

The listing of alternate colors will insure that you receive yarn to make the garments of your choice and that we do not have to write and say 'sorry, we are out of the color you ordered, will you accept an alternate?'

All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.


-  Increase
-  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.


-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

-  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.





-  Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.

REPEAT the above for each complete row.








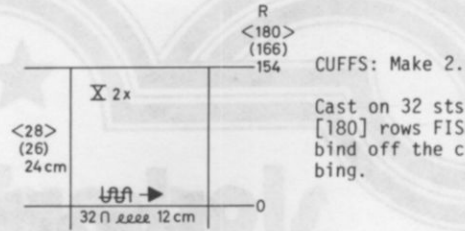


WOMAN'S JACKET

SIZE: 8/10 (12/14) [16/18]
 YARN: Alanda Tweed
 GRAMS: 700 750 800
 TENSION: 9 or 10
 GAUGE: 11 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with Fisherman's Rib for the Collar, Cuffs and Pockets.

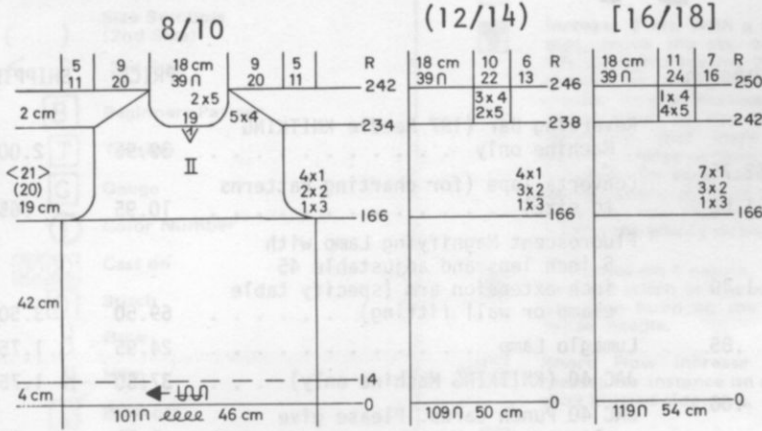
FINISHING: See General Instructions.



Cast on 32 sts. and work 154 (166) [180] rows FISHERMAN'S RIB, then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

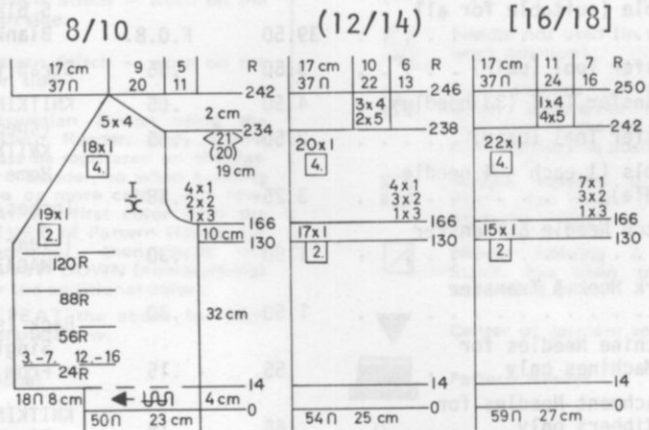
BACK: II

Cast on 101 (109) [119] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 166.
 SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 7x]. Knit to Row 234 (238) [242]. Bind off the center 19 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.
 *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME:
 FOR SHOULDER, bind off 4 sts. 5x. (5 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 1x). [5 sts. 4x, 4 sts. 1x].
 FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 2x.
 Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 234 (238) [242] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



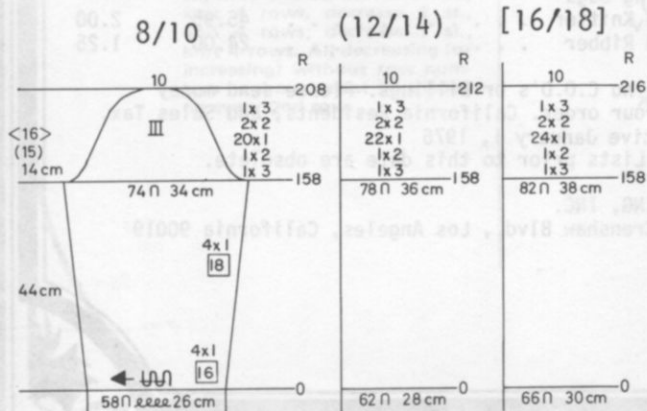
FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

DO NOT MAKE BUTTONHOLES IN THIS SECTION.
 Cast on 50 (54) [59] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 14, then with a separate yarn, cast on 18 sts. on the LEFT (right for 2nd section) side. Knit to Row 130.
 Begin the NECK SHAPING and SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back after Row 166. ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 19x (17x) [15x], every 4th row 18x (20x) [22x] and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 234 (238) [242], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
 Work the 2nd section with reverse shaping, casting on from RIGHT to LEFT. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0 and make BUTTONHOLES over needles 3 to 7 and 12 to 16 counting from the RIGHT edge after Rows 24, 56, 88, 120.



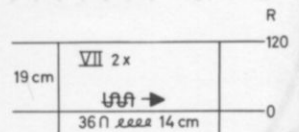
COLLAR: VI Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 114 (117) [119] sts. and work FISHERMAN'S RIB. After Row 4, on the RIGHT (left for 2nd section), bind off 2 sts. every 4th row 19x, every 2nd row 19x. After Row 116, bind off the remaining sts. the crochet method for Ribbing.



SLEEVE: III

Cast on 58 (62) [66] sts. and work Stockinette stitch.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 16th row 4x, every 18th row 4x. Knit to Row 158.
 SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 20x (22x) [24x], 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x. After Row 208 (212) [216], bind off the remaining 10 sts.



POCKET: VII Make 2.

Cast on 36 sts. and work 120 rows FISHERMAN'S RIB. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

WOMAN'S HAT & BAG

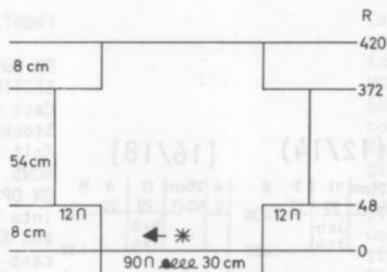
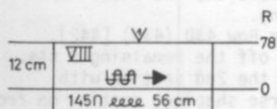
SIZE: Hat: to fit a 22" to 26" head measurement.
 YARN: Alanda Tweed
 GRAMS: 450
 TENSION: 9 or 10
 GAUGE: 15 sts. 30 rows = 5 cm (2")

Hat: Stockinette stitch with band in Fisherman's Rib. Bag: A Holding Position Design on the Purl side. Follow the Line Drawing. KNITKING machine owners, use Wheel No. W4 and push in the right Retractor Button and leave it there.

FINISHING: Hat: Sew sections of crown together then sew on band. Bag: Cut lining for bag before sewing. Sew bag and lining separately then sew the lining to bag. Attach to handle.

HAT BAND:

Cast on 145 sts. and work 78 rows FISHERMAN'S RIB on the KNIT side (KNITKING machine owners, put the Gate Cam Release Lever of the Ribber to the needle heels. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

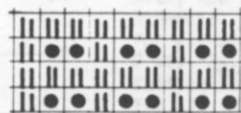
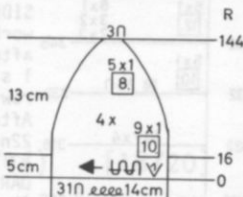


BAG:

Cast on 90 sts. and work in Holding Position Design. Knit to Row 48 then ON EACH SIDE, cast on 12 sts. (use a separate yarn for left side) Knit to Row 372. ON EACH SIDE, bind off 12 sts. Knit to Row 420. Bind off.

HAT CROWN: Make 4.

Cast on 31 sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 16. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 9x, every 8th row 5x. After Row 144, bind off the remaining 3 sts.

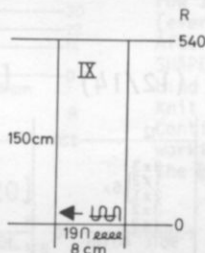

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16/18]
 YARN: Alanda Tweed
 GRAMS: 2250 2300 2350
 TENSION: 8 to 10
 GAUGE: 12 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch worn on the Purl side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. For the Hood, with knit side together, fold in half, pin, then sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neckline (see picture).



BELT: IX

Cast on 19 sts. and work Stockinette stitch to Row 540, then bind off.

BACK: II

Cast on 168 (178) [188] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 14, then work SHORT ROWS.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 40 sts. before knitting the next 2 rows. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position, 10 sts. 4x ON EACH SIDE, and AFTER ROW 22, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 14x, every 8th row 13x. After Row 266, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 22nd row 3x. Knit to Row 332.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off

3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 8x]. Knit to Row 412 (416) [418].

Bind off the center 22 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

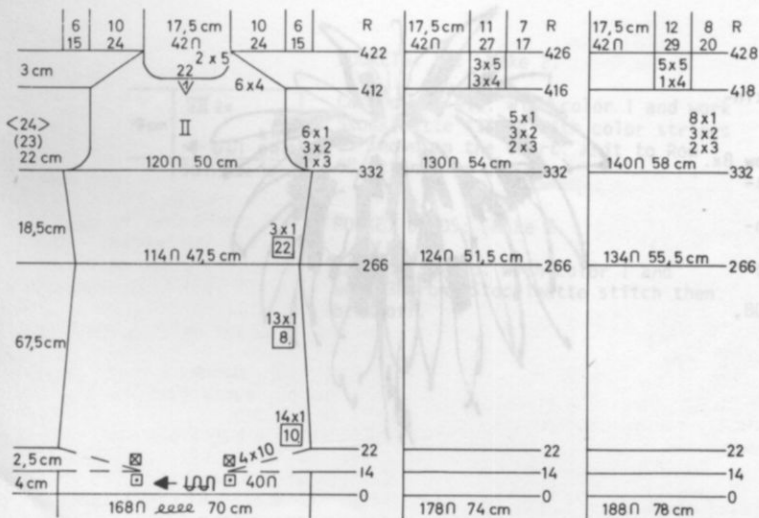
*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off

4 sts. 6x. (4 sts. 3x, 5 sts. 3x). [4 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 5x].

FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 2x.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 412 (416) [418] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

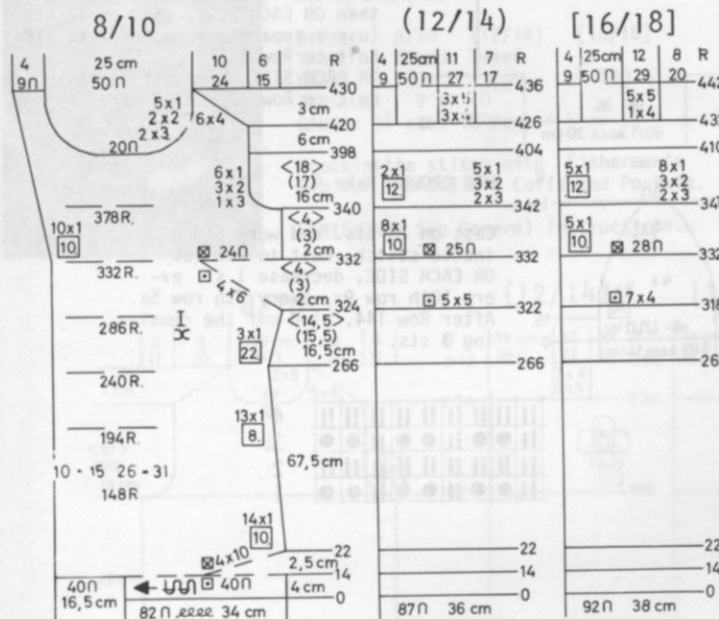

FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.



DO NOT MAKE BUTTONHOLES IN THIS SECTION.

Cast on 82 (87) [92] sts. and work Stockinette stitch.

Knit to Row 13, then WORK SHORT ROWS.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 40 sts. 1x and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 14, cast on 40 sts. on the LEFT (right for 2nd section) side. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position, 10 sts. 4x, and after Row 22, ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 14x, every 8th row 13x.

After Row 266, increase 1 st. every 22nd row 3x, and after Row 323 (321) [317], work SHORT ROWS for the BUST DART.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 6 sts. 4x (5 sts. 5x) [4 sts. 7x].

Bring all the needles back into working position before knitting the next row.

After Row 332, ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX INCREASE for FACING AND AT THE SAME TIME SHAPE

ARMHOLE same as the back after Row 340 (342) [346].

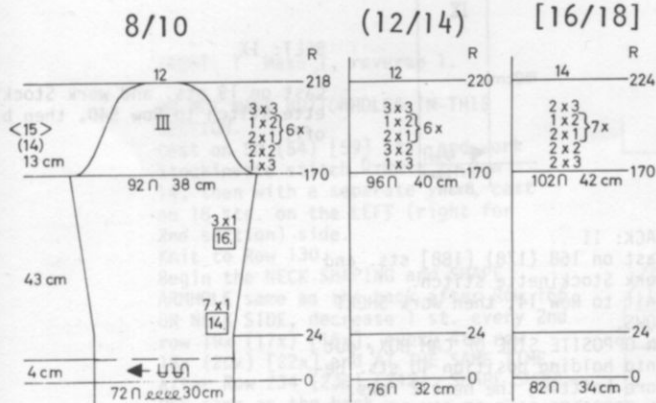
FOR FACING, increase 1 st. every 10th row 10x (8x) [5x], every 12th row 0x (2x) [5x]

AND AT THE SAME TIME after Row 398 (404) [410], SHAPE NECK. Leave 39 (42) [44] needles on the RIGHT (left for 2nd section) in working position and put the remainder on the left (right) into holding position.

*ON NECK SIDE, on every 2nd row, bind off for all sizes, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x, * AND SHAPE SHOULDER same as the Back after Row 420 (426) [432].

Bring all the needles into working position, bind off 20 sts. for NECK, turn the Row Counter back to 398 (404) [410] and complete the left side (right for 2nd section). Follow the instructions from * to ** and don't forget to complete the increases for facing.

After Row 430 (436) [442], bind off the remaining 9 sts. Work the 2nd section with reverse shaping, casting on from RIGHT to LEFT. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0, and MAKE BUTTONHOLES over needles 10 to 15 and 26 to 31 counting from the RIGHT edge after the rows shown on the Chart.



SLEEVE: III

Cast on 72 (76) [82] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 24.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 7x, every 16th row 3x.

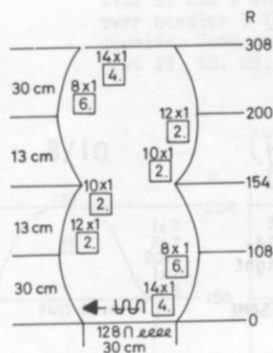
Knit to Row 170.

SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, *1 st. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, and REPEAT from * 5x more, 3 sts. 3x.

(3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, *1 st. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, and REPEAT from * 5x more, 3 sts. 3x).

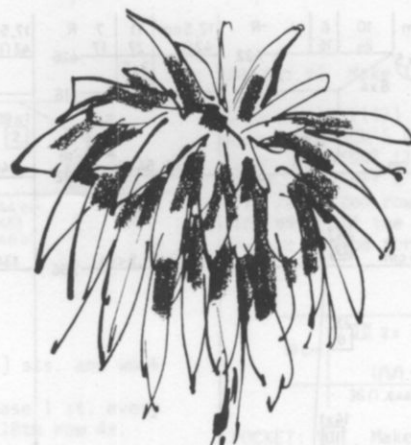
[3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, *1 st. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, and REPEAT from * 6x more, 3 sts. 2x].

After Row 218 (220) [224], bind off the remaining 12 (12) [14] sts.



HOOD

Cast on 128 sts. and work Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 14x, every 6th row 8x. After Row 108, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 22x. After Row 154, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 2nd row 22x. After Row 200, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 8x, every 4th row 14x. After Row 308, bind off the remaining sts.

WOMAN'S JACKET

SIZES: 10/12 (14/16) [18/20]
 YARN: Binia
 GRAMS:
 color 1 450 500 550
 color 2 200 250 300
 TENSION: 6 to 8
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with repeated color stripes and knit sideways on the machine. The purl side is the right side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



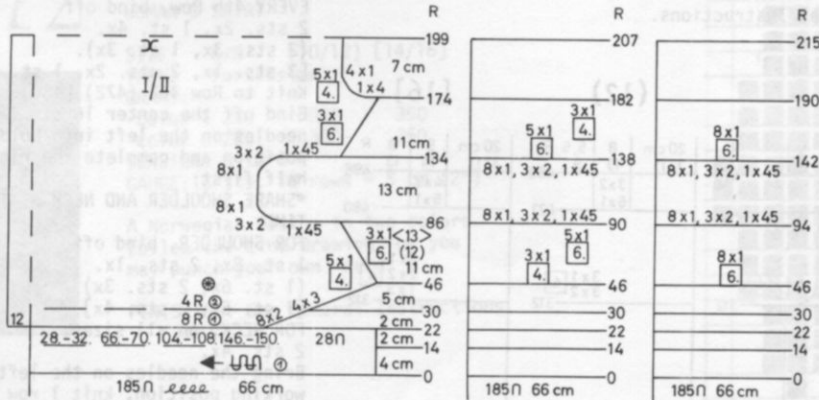
FRONT & BACK: II

Cast on 185 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 14, then make **BUTTON-HOLES** over needles 28 to 32, 66 to 70, 104 to 108, 146 to 150 counting from the **LEFT** edge. Knit to Row 22. Bind off 28 sts. on the **RIGHT** and with a separate yarn, cast on 12 sts. on the **LEFT** for hem. Continue with **REPEATED** color stripes as shown on the Chart. **ON NECK SIDE**, cast on 2 sts. 8x, 3 sts. 4x and **AT THE SAME TIME**, after Row 30, make **BUTTONHOLES** over the same needles as you did before (beginning with needle 40 because of the 12 cast on sts. for hem). After Row 46 **SHAPE SHOULDER**: decrease 1 st. every 4th row 5x, every 6th row 3x. (every 4th row 3x, every 6th row 5x). [every 6th row 8x]. After Row 86 (90) [94] **SHAPE ARMHOLE**: For all sizes, bind off 45 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x. 1 st. 8x. Knit to Row 112 (116) [120]. For all sizes, increase 1 st. 8x, 2 sts. 3x, 45 sts. 1x. After Row 134 (138) [142] **SHAPE SHOULDER**: Increase 1 st. every 6th row 3x, every 4th row 5x. (every 6th row 5x, every 4th row 3x). [every 6th row 8x]. After Row 174 (182) [190], **SHAPE NECK**: For all sizes, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 1 st. 4x. Knit to Row 199 (207) [215]. Continue with the 2nd half by working backwards and **OMIT** the Buttonholes.

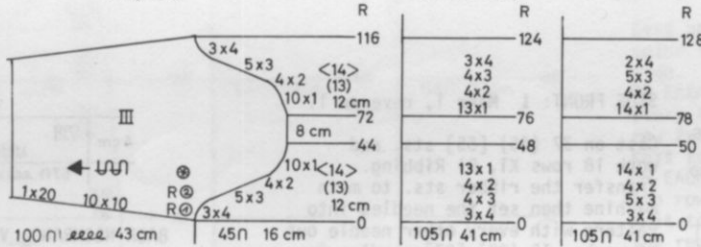

SLEEVE: III

Cast on 100 (105) [105] sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch with **REPEATED** color stripes as shown on the Chart. **SHAPE CAP ON CAM BOX SIDE** and work **SHORT ROWS** opposite side of Cam Box. Put all but 10 sts. on the right side into holding position, knit 2 rows. Now shape **BOTH** sides **AT THE SAME TIME**. **ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX**, bring back into working position 10 sts. 9x **AND AT THE SAME TIME** for **CAP**, cast on 4 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 5x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 10x. (4 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 4x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 13x). [4 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 5x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 14x]. Knit to Row 72 (76) [78]. **REVERSE** the procedure for the **CAP SHAPING**, following the Chart, binding off instead of casting on and **AT THE SAME TIME**, after Row 98 (106) [110], work **SHORT ROWS**: **ON OPPOSITE SIDE** of Cam Box, put into holding position 10 sts. 9x. After Row 116 (124) [128], bring all the needles back into working position and bind off loosely.

SLEEVE CUFFS: Make 2.

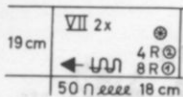
Cast on 63 sts. with color 1 and work 30 rows Stockinette stitch then bind off.

POCKETS: VII Make 2.

Cast on 50 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Knit to Row 68, then bind off.

POCKET BANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 50 sts. with color 1 and work 30 rows Stockinette stitch then bind off.

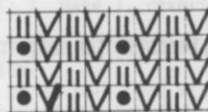

A Holding Position Design over every other needle. The out of work needles ARE counted in the Stitch and Row Gauge. The purl side is the right side. Follow the Line Drawing. KNIT-KING machine owners use Wheel No. 4 and push in the RIGHT Retractor Button before knitting the 5th row, release it after knitting the 6th row. Front sections are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.

BACK: II

Cast on 137 (153) [173] sts. and work 18 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Transfer the Ribber sts. to main machine then set into Pattern with every other needle OUT OF WORK.

68 (76) [86] needles in work. Continue in the Holding Position Design. Knit to Row 312. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, on EVERY 4th Row, bind off 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x. (2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x]. Knit to Row 462 (472) [480]. Bind off the center 16 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

Knit to Row 78 (86) [100]. SHAPE CENTER BACK AND FRONT AT THE SAME TIME. ON ALL SIZES, for Center back, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x, then 1 st. every 10th row 4x. 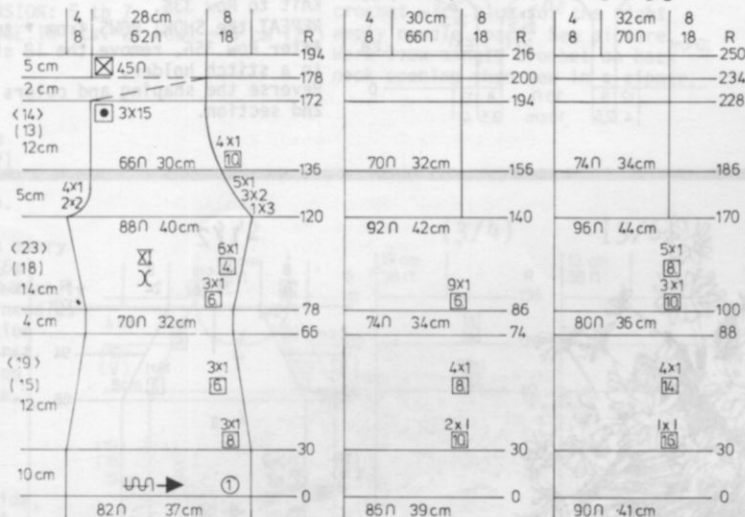

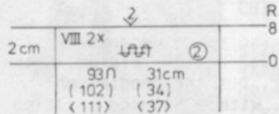

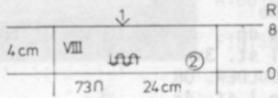

Knit to Row 136.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 6x, every 6th row 3x. After Row 176, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 16x, every 2nd row 10x.

Knit to Row 268

ON THE RIGHT (left for 2nd section) remove 18 sts. onto a stitch holder. Knit to Row 292.

*WORK SHORT ROWS.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 1 st. 3x, 2 sts. 2x ON EACH SIDE

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

$\begin{matrix} 5x1 \\ \boxed{6} \end{matrix}$ The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...
3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x].
As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITTING machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS:

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box (or Slide) are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the Trip Control Lever so that only 1 row registers.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITTING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part.

Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn - Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please be sure to read the GENERAL INSTRUCTION PAGE in this issue of KNITKING MAGAZINE. We have added some new copy which should be a help to everyone, especially to our new knitters. It tells you now to read the instructions when working from the printed copy or when working from the Charts, or a combination of both. Another important addition is... Instructions for holding stitches when knitting in Pattern - especially while shaping the neck and shoulders of a section. This will continue to be a part of every KNITKING MAGAZINE, so you will be able to refer to it whenever you need.

DK 282 - You will notice that the Woman's Jacket DK 282 was knitted on an Empisal 323 knitting machine with Ribber. We thought it so pretty, we included it especially for our Studio machine subscribers. The Punch Pile is made using Card No. 4. For KNITKING machine owners and other Japanese machines, instructions can be followed as given, but you use the Norwegian Design in 2 colors shown on the Line Drawing and punch your own card.

MARKING SECTIONS OF GARMENT

We have had a few letters from subscribers telling us they find it difficult to put their garments together. From time to time, we mention the importance of MARKING sections of garment so that when you are ready to put them together, the marks match up, thus making it easy for you to sew them together. Here is a reminder on how to do this.

As you are knitting, tie a small piece of contrast yarn ON EACH SIDE of your knitting, every 50 rows or so. When you begin the neck shaping, take a piece of contrast yarn and tie it to the center neck stitch. Do this on both front and back sections... Mark the center stitch at the top of cap shaping of sleeve before you bind it off. Mark the center of Collar or Neckband... If the Collar or Neckband is double, mark the center of cast on and center of bind off row. If you are knitting a Jacket that has a facing where you must cast on a number of stitches after knitting the underhem, you should mark the center of these stitches... so that if the number of stitches to cast on is 24, half of this will be part of the front and half will be the facing. A good way to mark the center fold line is: Thread a tapestry needle with light weight contrast yarn and make a running basting line BETWEEN the 12th and 13th sts. counting from the front edge. Continue the line of basting every 30 or 40 rows as you are knitting. When you are ready to put your garment together, you have a perfect mark for the fold line. Pull out the contrast marking when you have completed your garment. If you mark all sections as you are knitting them, you will find that the sides match perfectly, the sleeves fit into the armholes, the neckbands and collars fall into place and what might be a chore now becomes a pleasure because it all goes together so easily.... try it.

NEW KNITKING YARN CATALOGUE...

We had no alternative... we just had to hold up production of the new Catalogue... otherwise you would be receiving Catalogues showing obsolete yarns and colors.

We maintain Catalogues for approximately two years, so obviously we have to wait for the new range before completing our Catalogue and because we know of no facility for making yarn catalogues in the U.S.A., we have them made in Europe and have to allow for an additional four weeks shipping time.

SO PLEASE... don't pay for a new Catalogue until we tell you. The yarns used for garments in this issue are either in stock or on the high seas and we have all of the listed colors available... Again, discounts to our subscribers are substantial, so place your order early and try to choose alternate colors as we do run out of the colors used in the original garments.

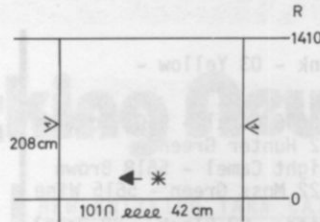

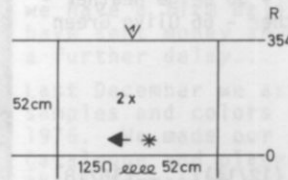


A Weaving Pattern. KNITKING machine owners use Wheel No. W3. Follow the Line Drawing.

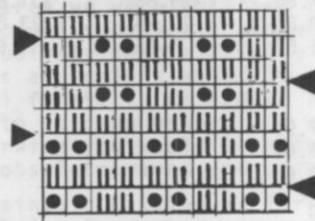


SIDES: Cast on 101 sts. and work 1410 rows in Weaving Pattern. Bind off.
