Watch out for the next issue of KNITTING MAGAZINE. ... it will be simply FANTASTIC.

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



- 4** Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1 **4** means decrease (or increase) 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

-  Increase
-  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.
-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
-  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.
-  Pattern Stitch
-  Pattern Stitch — worn on the Knit side.
-  Pattern Stitch — worn on the Purl side.
-  Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.
REPEAT the above for each complete row.
-  Repeat

II = Back
III = Sleeve

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as [12/14] and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1

6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 [136] [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.

Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.

Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS:

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box (or Slide) are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the Trip Control Lever so that only 1 row registers.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping'). Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn - Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Use the 820 Color Changer, or you may hand feed the stripes. The purl side is the right side. You will need 19 plastic rings for the belt.



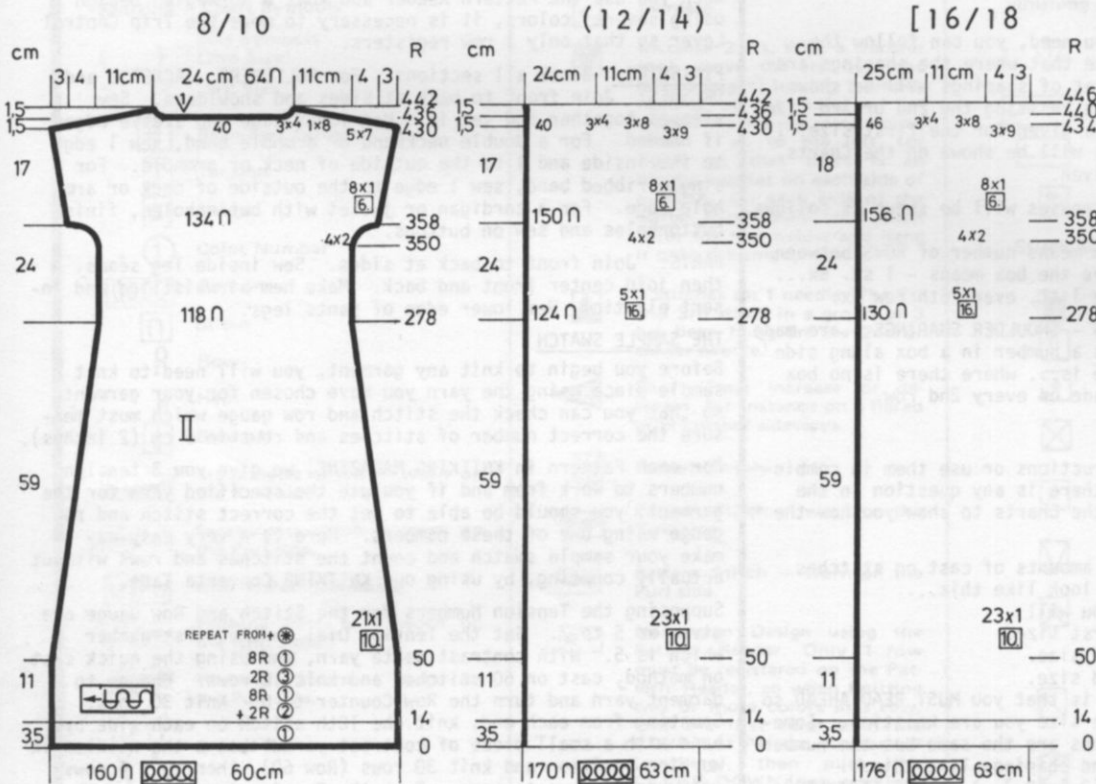
WOMAN'S DRESS

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16]
 YARN: Summertime
 GRAMS:
 color 1 500 500 550
 color 2 100 100 100
 color 3 100 100 100
 TENSION: 9 or 10
 GAUGE: 13 1/2 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Work 2 rows single crochet with color 1 around the sleeve edges. Work 24 single crochets around each ring, alternating the colors and attaching them together as you work (see Picture) and make a 30 cm (11 3/4") cord for belt tie.

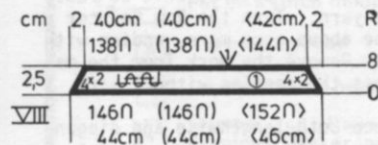
BACK: II

Cast on 160 (170) [176] sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. With lowered tension, knit to Row 14, then continue with garment tension and the REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 50, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 21x (23x) [23x]. Knit to Row 278.
 For the 2nd and 3rd sizes ONLY, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 16th row 5x.
 After Row 350, ON EACH SIDE, cast on 2 sts. 4x.
 After Row 358, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 8x.
 After Row 430 (430) [434], SHAPE SHOULDER and watch for NECK SHAPING.
 FOR SHOULDER, bind off 7 sts. 5x, 8 sts. 1x. (9 sts. 3x, 8 sts. 3x). [9 sts. 3x, 8 sts. 3x].
 FOR NECK, after Row 436 (436) [440], bind off the center 40 (40) [46] sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 3x for all sizes. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 436 (436) [440] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.



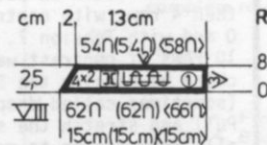
FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 278.
 For the 2nd and 3rd sizes only, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 16th row 5x.
 After Row 350 (356) [358], bind off the center 14 sts, put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *ON SIDE EDGE, cast on 2 sts. 4x and after Row 358 (364) [364], increase 1 st. every 6th row 8x.
 After Row 411 (417) [421], SHAPE NECK: Bind off (watch for shoulder shapening) 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x. (4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x].
 FOR SHOULDER: After Row 430 (436) [440], bind off 7 sts. 5x, 8 sts. 1x. (9 sts. 3x, 8 sts. 3x). [9 sts. 3x, 8 sts. 3x].
 Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 350 (356) [358] and complete the left half. Follow the instruction from *.



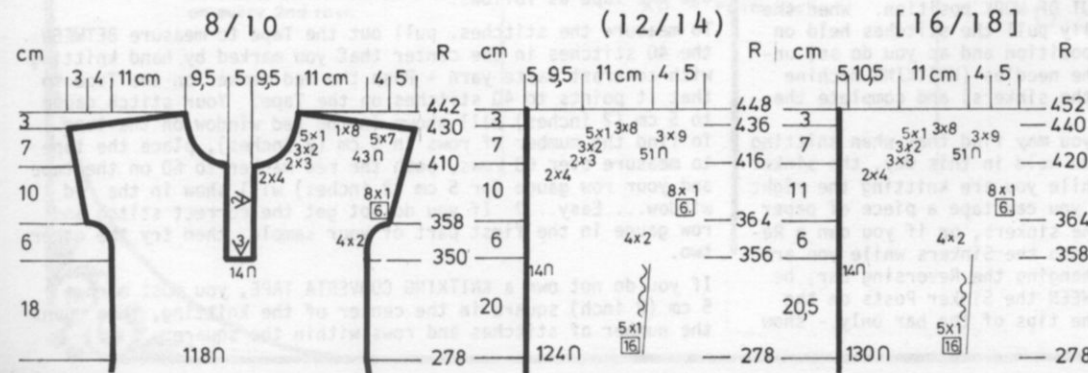
NECKBAND: VIII

Cast on 146 (146) [152] sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 2 sts. every 2nd row 4x then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



FRONT BAND: VIII Make 2.

Cast on 62 (62) [66] sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON THE LEFT (right for 2nd section), decrease 2 sts. 4x, then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

WOMAN'S JACKET & SCARF

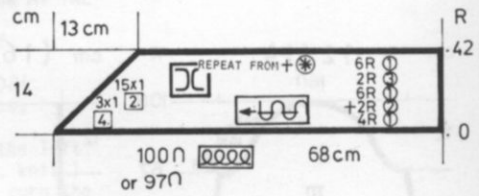
SIZES: 8/10 (12/14)
YARN: Euro Sport = color 1
 Capriccio = color 2
 Capriccio = color 3

GRAMS:
 color 1 400 400
 color 2 25 25
 color 3 25 25

OR - You may use looped Mohair if you have some - on the AM 3 ONLY.
TENSION: 6 to 8
GAUGE: 9 1/2 sts. 14 rows = 5 cm (2")

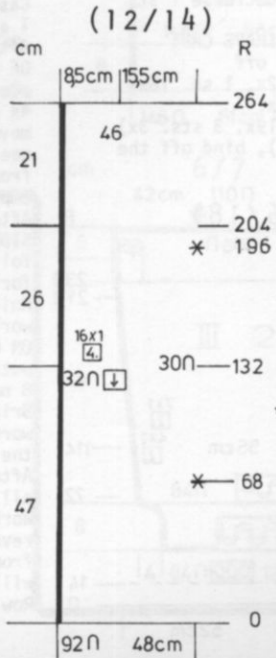
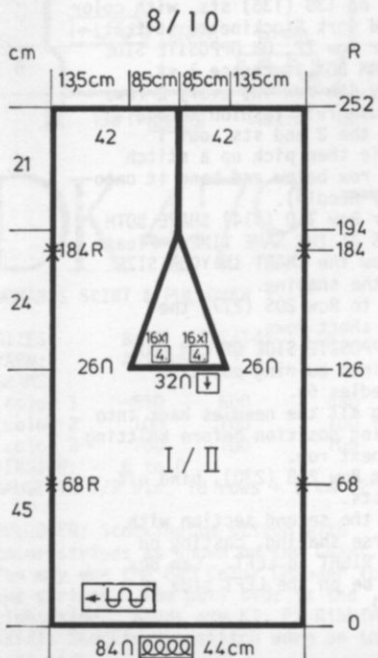
Stockinette stitch over EVERY OTHER NEEDLE. Worn on the purl side. Trim with Capriccio. The Scarf is knitted in color stripes as shown on the Chart.

FINISHING: Fold and match the marked edges, then sew up side seams. Around all edges, work 1 row single crochet with color 2, 1 row with color 3 and 1 row REVERSE single crochet with color 1. **SCARF:** Sew back seam, then work 1 row single crochet around all edges with color 1.



SCARF: Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 100 (97 for the AM 3 machine) sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. ON THE LEFT (right for 2nd section), decrease 1 st. every 4th row 3x, every 2nd row 15x. After Row 42, bind off the remaining stitches.



BACK & FRONT I/II made in 1 piece.
 Cast on 84 (92) sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 68. Mark each side with a bit of contrast waste yarn. Knit to Row 126 (132). Bind off the center 32 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *ON NECK SIDE, INCREASE 1 st. every 4th row 16x and after Row 184 (196), mark the side edge as you did before. Knit to Row 252 (264) then bind off. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 126 (132) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

BACK: II

Cast on 140 (146) sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 30, then work the Pattern sets as shown on the Line Drawing and following the instructions for Pattern. AT THE SAME TIME, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x. Knit to Row 194 (198) SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. Knit to Row 272 (276). Bind off the center 30 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *SHAPE SHOULDER and NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 6 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 2x. (6 sts. 3x, 5 sts. 2x). FOR NECK, on both sizes, bind off 2 sts. 4x. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 272 (276) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

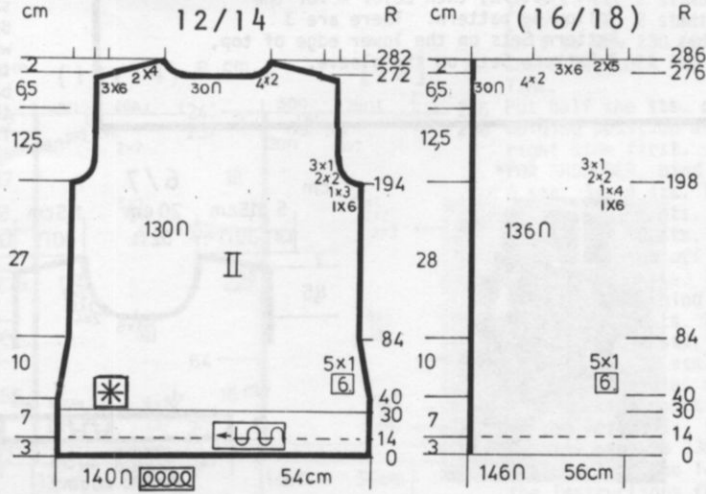
WOMAN'S SHORTS & TOP

SIZES: 12/14 (16/18)
YARN: Allegro
GRAMS:
 color 1 500 600
 color 2 50 50
 color 3 50 50
 color 4 50 50
TENSION: 7 to 9
GAUGE: 13 sts. 20 rows = 5 cm (2")



Stockinette stitch with a Pattern worked over 3 rows. Be sure to read the Instructions. Worn on the purl side. Crochet around neckline.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Crochet around neckline as follows: With color 3, work 2 rows single crochet around neck, then work for Row 3, single crochet in first st, skip 2 stitches, *5 double crochets in next stitch, skip 2, 1 single crochet in next stitch, skip 2 and REPEAT from * around. For the ties, make a chain 20 cm (8") long then work the same crochet along the chain as you did for the neckline. Make another tie. Sew ties to center front and tie in bow - see picture.

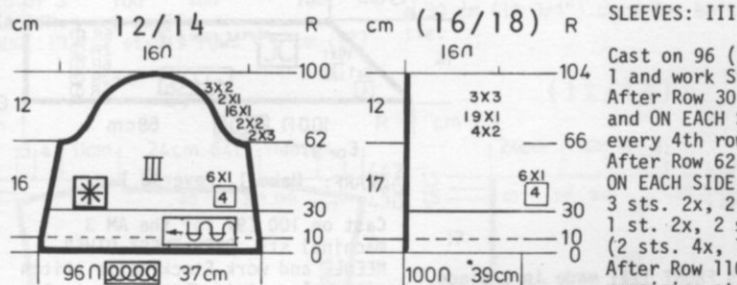
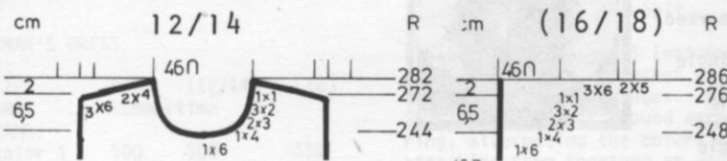

FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 244 (248). Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, for both sizes, bind off 6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 1x and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 272 (276) same as the back.

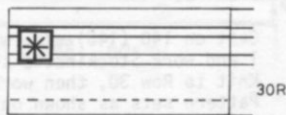
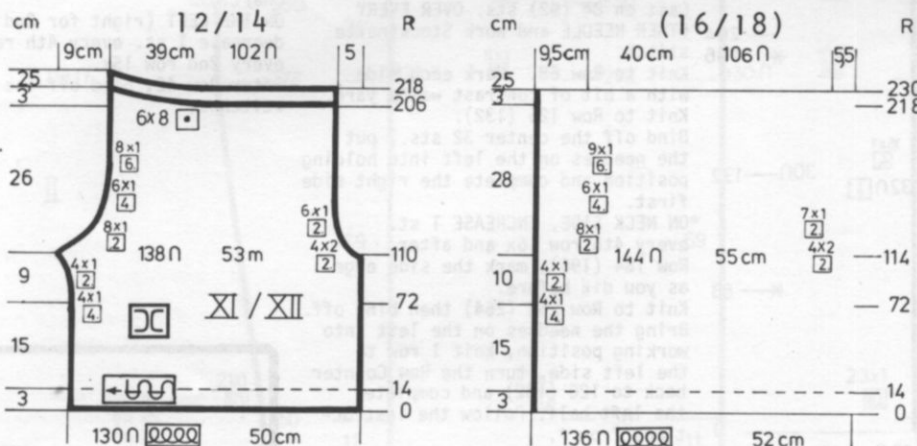


SLEEVES: III

Cast on 96 (100) sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. After Row 30, begin the Pattern and ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 6x. After Row 62 (66) SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 16x, 1 st. 2x, 2 sts. 3x. (2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 19x, 3 sts. 3x). After Row 110 (116), bind off the remaining sts.

PANTS: XI/XII Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 130 (136) sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. After Row 72, ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, increase 1 st. every 4th row 4x, every 2 rows 4x (use full fashion method - move the 2 end sts. out 1 needle then pick up a stitch from row below and hang it onto empty needle). After Row 110 (114) SHAPE BOTH SIDES AT THE SAME TIME. Please follow the CHART IN YOUR SIZE for the shaping. Knit to Row 205 (217) then work short rows. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 8 needles 6x. Bring all the needles back into working position before knitting the next row. After Row 218 (230), bind off all sts. Work the second section with reverse shaping, casting on from RIGHT to LEFT. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0.



After knitting the 30 rows for lower edge of top and sleeves, knit *1 row color 2. Bring the needles forward so that the stitches go behind the latches. Make sure all the needle latches remain open. Place color 1 across the open needles and knit EACH STITCH BY HAND pulling the stitch all the way back against the back needle rail (in the out of work position). The stitches are really knitted only HALF WAY.

Leave the stitches in this position until you have them all knitted and lined up. Now, carefully pull the knitting forward into knitting position (or you can bring them into holding position with the stitches again moving in back of the needle latches) Be sure to have plenty of weights on your knitting. Knit 1 row color 2. Knit 10 rows color 1. REPEAT from *, changing to color 3 for the single hand knit rows in next Pattern, then color 4 for the following pattern. There are 3 Pattern Sets on the lower edge of top, 7 Pattern Sets on the sleeve.

FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 278 (286). Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, for both sizes, bind off 6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 320 (328). Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 278 (286) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

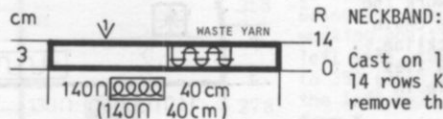
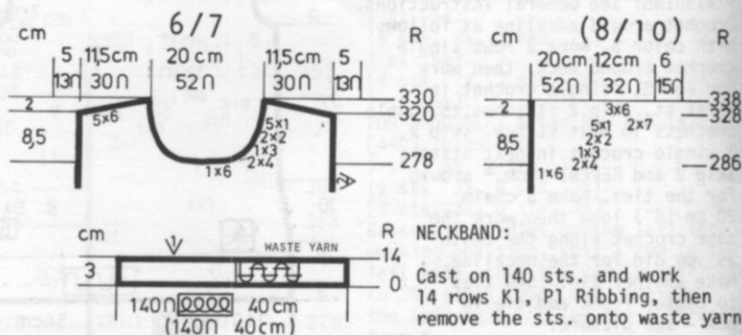

WOMAN'S PULLOVER

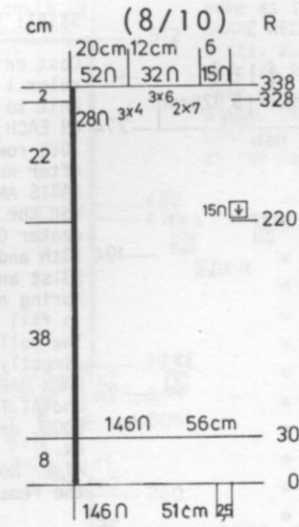
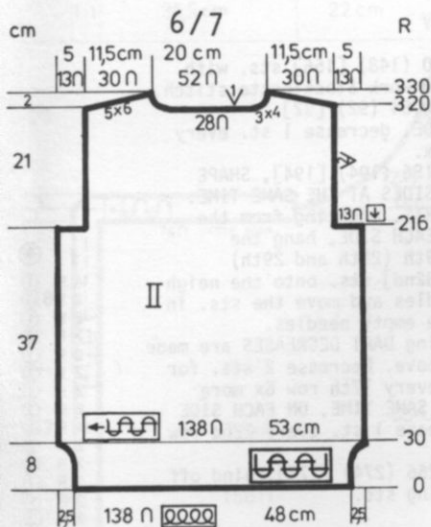
SIZES: 6/7 (8/10)
YARN: Nicole
GRAMS: 450 500
TENSION: 8 to 10
GAUGE: 13 sts. 25 rows = 5 cm (2")

Pattern: Half FISHERMAN'S OR ENGLISH RIB. Purl side. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



NECKBAND: Cast on 140 sts. and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing, then remove the sts. onto waste yarn.



BACK: II
 Cast on 138 (146) sts. and work 30 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in ENGLISH RIB Pattern. Knit to Row 216 (220) ON EACH SIDE, bind off 13 sts. Knit to Row 320 (328). Bind off the center 28 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.
 FOR SHOULDER, bind off 6 sts. 5x. (7 sts. 2x, 6 sts. 3x).
 FOR NECK, on both sizes, bind off 4 sts. 3x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 320 (328) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

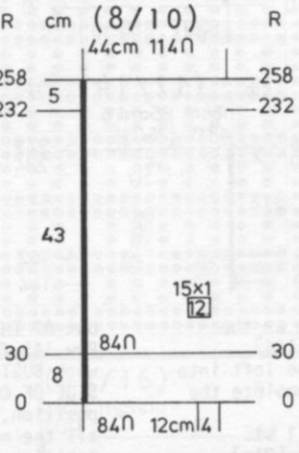
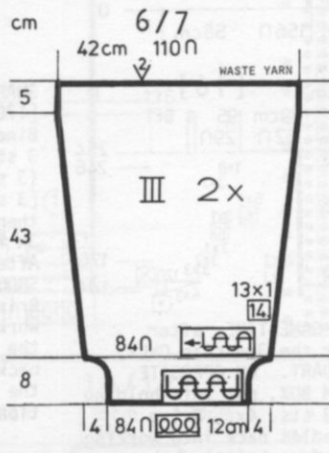

WOMAN'S SKIRT & PULLOVER

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16]
 YARN: Allegro
 GRAMS:
 color 1 550 600 650
 color 2 100 100 100
 color 3 100 100 100
 TENSION: 6 to 8
 GAUGE: 13 1/2 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")

PULLOVER: Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. You may use the 820 Color Changer for the stripes. The purl side is the right side. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.
 SKIRT: Stockinette stitch worn on the purl side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



SLEEVES: III
 Cast on 84 (84) sts. and work 30 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in ENGLISH RIB. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 13x. (every 12th row 15x). After Row 232 (232) mark each side with a bit of contrast waste yarn. Knit to Row 258, then remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn. Sew up the sleeve to the marked edges. The opening at top of sleeve fits into the armhole bind-offs on front and back.

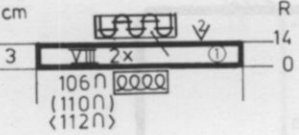
BACK: II

Cast on 126 (136) [146] sts. with color 1 and work 18 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Move the Cam Box to the right side, Bring all the needles into working position and knit to Row 176 (196) [215]. ON EACH SIDE, remove 58 (65) [66] sts. onto contrast waste yarn. Knit to Row 246 (274) [297]. Transfer every other stitch to the Ribber and work K1, P1 Ribbing to Row 256 (284) [307] then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



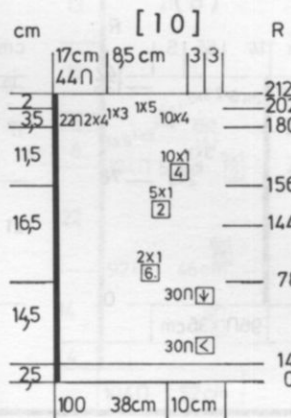
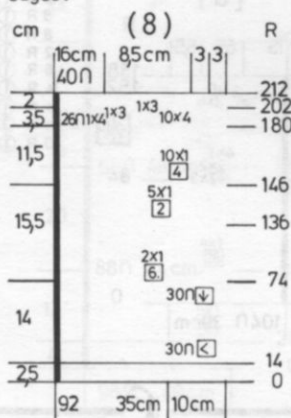
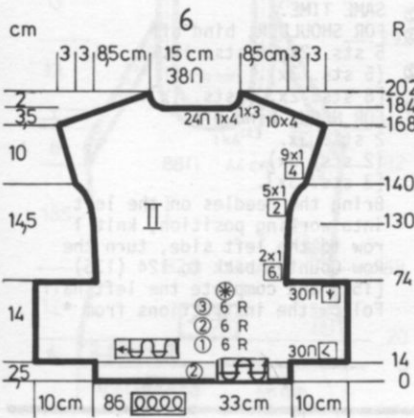

CHILD'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 6 (8) [10]
YARN: Amore
GRAMS:
 color 1 100 150 150
 color 2 50 100 100
 color 3 50 100 100
TENSION: 6 to 8
GAUGE: 13 sts. 20 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Waist band, K1, P1 Ribbing. Worn on the purl side.

FINISHING: Sew side seams and shoulders. Sew pocket lining to front pocket extension, tuck inside. Work 1 row single crochet, then 1 row reverse single crochet around sleeve edges.



BACK: II

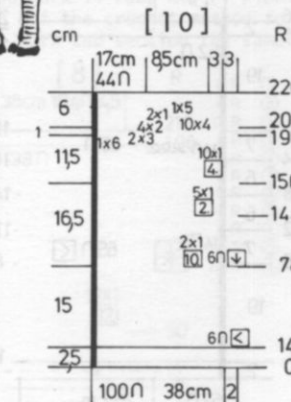
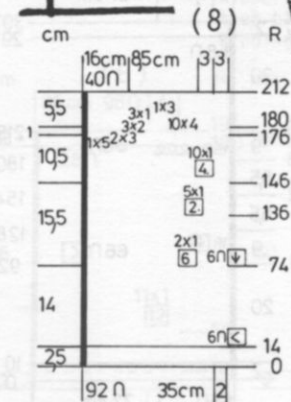
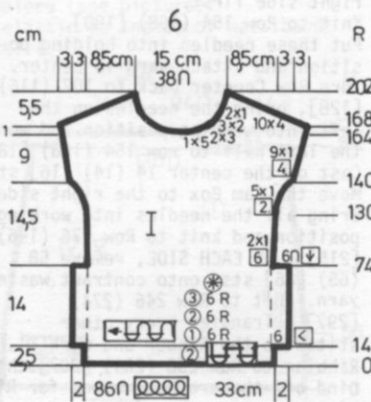
Cast on 86 (92) [100] sts. with color 2 and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart.
 ON EACH SIDE, cast on 30 sts.
 Knit to Row 74 (74) [78].
 ON EACH SIDE, bind off 30 sts.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 2x.
 Knit to Row 130 (136) [144].
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 2nd row 5x, every 4th row 9x. (every 2nd row 5x, every 4th row 10x). [every 2nd row 5x, every 4th row 10x].
 After Row 168 (180) [180], SHAPE SHOULDER and watch for NECK SHAPING.
 *FOR SHOULDER, bind off 4 sts. 10x, (4 sts. 10x, 3 sts. 1x), [4 sts. 10x, 5 sts. 1x],
 FOR NECK, after Row 184 (202) [202], bind off the center 24(26)[22]sts. put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x].
 Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 184 (202) [202] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * but don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.

FRONT: I

Cast on 86 (92) [100] sts. with color 2 and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart.
 ON EACH SIDE, cast on 6 sts.
 Knit to Row 74 (74) [78].
 ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 2x, every 2nd row 5x. (every 6th row 2x, every 2nd row 5x). [every 10th row 2x, every 2nd row 5x].
 After Row 140 (146) [156], increase 1 st. every 4th row 9x (10x) [10x].
 After Row 164 (176) [198], put half the sts. on the left into holding position and
 *SHAPE NECK (watch for Shoulder Shaping).
 ON NECK SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x. (5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [6 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 2x].
 AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 168 (180) [198], SHAPE SHOULDER SAME AS THE BACK.
 Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 168 (180) [202] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.





KnitKing News

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

Do you turn down a pattern because it seems to be too long or too short for you???... We recommend that you check the length of garments using the total number of rows as a guide. Wherever there is straight knitting such as on the lower edge of a sweater - the straight rows before the shaping of a sleeve cap, etc., you can add rows or subtract rows as needed without becoming confused - the trick is to add or subtract the rows between shapings, then simply turn your Row Counter to the row shown where you begin the shaping. DK 493 in this issue will fit sizes 10 to 14, but the length may be too long for a size 10 in both the body of garment and the sleeve length - so take off an inch or two - set your row counter to the shaping row and continue.

HOW ABOUT A DIFFERENT BIND-OFF

One of our experts gave us this way to bind off. You will find it a slick way to bind off shoulder stitches especially, but we like it for any bind-offs.

If you have shaped the shoulders using short rows and removed the sts. onto contrast waste yarn, try this method for binding off the back and front shoulders together... With right side of garment facing you, hang the back shoulder stitches onto the machine. With the wrong side of garment facing you, hang the matching front shoulder stitches onto these same needles. There are two sets of stitches on each needle. Be careful, where you wrapped the needle while working short rows, you will have 3 or even 4 sts. on a needle and you must be sure to pick up ALL the sts. Check carefully before you remove the waste yarn. Put the stitches behind the latches.

With garment yarn, knit the first stitch (by hand of course) and put the stitch behind the latch. Knit the 2nd stitch then move this stitch to the first stitch in FRONT of the latch, then pull it through the stitch behind the latch. Move this stitch over to the empty needle on the left. Anchor the edge so that you will have a nice even tension as you work across from left to right (left handed people can work from right to left). *Knit the 2nd stitch, move it to the 1st stitch, in front of the latch, then knit it off by pulling it through the stitch in back of the latch, move it over to empty needle on left and REPEAT from * across the needles. When you have worked the last stitch, pull the yarn through the loop and cut. BEAUTIFUL.... This method can be used for ANY BIND-OFFS... try it.

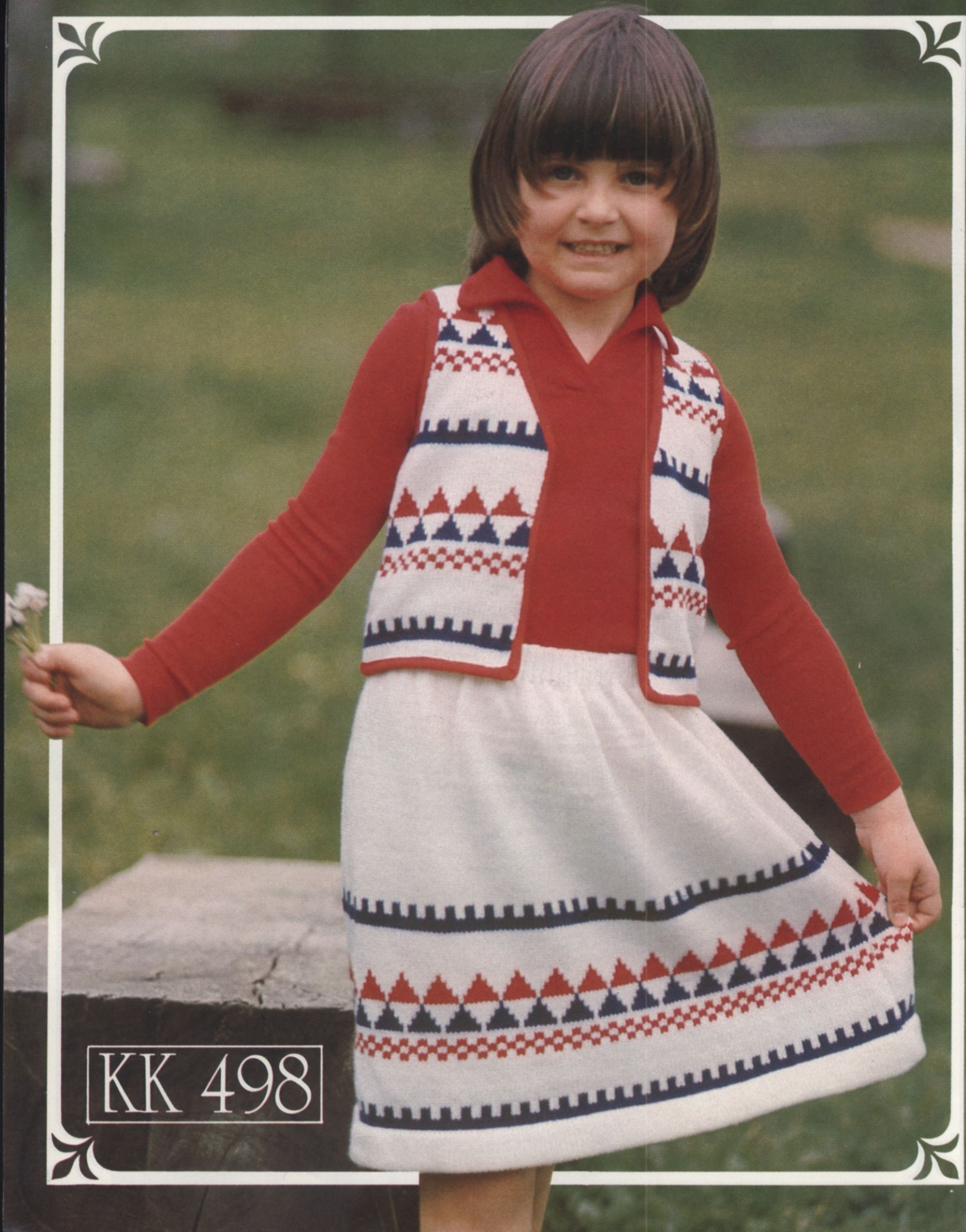
