Our very first Open House and Seminar held on the KNITKING premises during October was a great success and we want to thank the several hundred customers who attended for their cooperation in assuring its success. Some classes were so popular, it was necessary to send out for extra chairs to accomodate the overflow crowds.

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit ... ?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows 5x1

6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts . Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this... Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size. Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.

Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 2 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

- TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.
- TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS:

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box (or Slide) are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the Trip Control Lever so that only 1 row registers.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagon-ally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn - Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will shown in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

[10 sts. 1x, 6 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x]. After Row 178 (188) [198], ON NECK SIDE, cast on sts. 2x, 4 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 1x, 2 10 sts. 1x. (Same as first size). 2 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 1x, 6 sts. 1x, 10 sts. 1x]. Put these sts. into holding position and move the Slide to the right side. Bring the needles on the left side of neck into working position, turn the Row Counter back to 168 (178) [188] and complete the neck shaping following the instructions from *. After Row 190 (200) [210], all sts. in Stockinettte stitch to Row 240 (254) [264]. Mark each side for sleeve as you did before then knit to Row 298 (318) [338]. Knit the Norwegian Design to Row 344 (364) [384]. Transfer every other stitch to the Ribber and work K1, P1 Ribbing to Row 356 (376) [396]. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

Cast on 50 (50) [54] sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing to Continue in Stockinette stitch.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 13x (15x) [15x]. After Row 126 (130) [134], work the Norwegian Border Design to Row 160 (164) [168]. Remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

Hang the 124 cast on sts. back onto the machine, decreasing 20 sts. evenly across. Knit 2 rows, remove on waste yarn.

*Hang back onto the machine, decreasing 20 sts. across as before and knit 2 rows. Remove onto waste yarn.

REPEAT from * 3x more, but the last time, remove the sts. onto a double strand of garment yarn and pull up and tie.

Cast on 128 (134) sts. and work Stockinette stitch to Row 16. Continue in Pattern. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 12th row 15x (16x). After Row 216, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. Knit to Row 286 (298). SHAPE SHOULDER and WATCH FOR NECK SHAPING: FOR SHOULDER, bind off 60 - 226 (5 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x, AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 290, (300) put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 11 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x.

> Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 290 (300) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.

FRONT BANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 160 (168) sts. and work 8 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

PULLOVER BACK: (color 2 for Pullover)

Cast on 82 sts. and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 66. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x. Knit to Row 114. SHAPE NECK and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 118. FOR NECK: Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 7 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 2x. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 5 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 1x. Move the Cam Box to the left side. turn the Row Counter back to 114 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

CROTCH SECTION:

then bind off.

Cast on 20 sts. with color 1 and

work 24 rows Stockinette stitch



PULLOVER FRONT:

Work the front the same as the back to Row 104. Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 7 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 5x and after Row 118, SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 104 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *

NECKBAND:

Sew 1 shoulder, then pick up 100 sts. around neckline and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

SLEEVES:

Cast on 40 sts. and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 5x, every 4th row 6x. Knit to Row 72. SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 9x, 2 sts. 3x. After Row 102, bind off the remaining sts.

COVERALL: Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 50 sts. with contrast waste varn and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, put Counter at 0 and work with garment yarn (color 1). Knit to Row 64. ON EACH SIDE, increase

1 st. 4x, 2 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 1x. Knit to Row 147 then work SHORT ROWS. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 36 sts. 1x, then 8 sts. 5x.

Bring all the needles back into working position and after Row 160, transfer every other stitch to the Ribber and work 10 Rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

With purl side facing you, hang 25 sts. of the front leg section held on waste yarn, then work the foot section.

Knit 26 rows then work SHORT ROWS. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 1 st. each row until 7 remain in center. Put back 1 st. until all are in work. Knit 26 rows.

REPEAT THE SHORT ROWS for heel, then remove onto waste yarn and graft (kitchener stitch) to the back leg section. Remove the waste yarn and sew up sides of foot. REPEAT for other foot section.



Cast on 21 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. After Row 50, make BUTTONHOLE over the center 5 sts. then ON EACH SIDE, on every 2nd row, bind off 2 sts. 5x.

FRONT & BACK TOP: 2 sections.

If you prefer, you can make the top as a separate garment but you must cast on and work 14 rows of K1, P1 Ribbing. The garment in picture has the top (worked without ribbing) sewn to the top of ribbed band of the pants and the instructions for this follow.

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 76 sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1. Put Counter at 0.

Knit to Row 44. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 2x. After Row 70, make picots by transferring every 2nd st. to the next needle and leave the empty needles in working position. Knit to Row 80 then bind off the remaining sts. Make the 2nd section the same.

COUCH THROW:

Cast on 197 sts. with color 1 and work 544 rows in Weaving Design then bind off.

BORDER TRIM:

Cast on 5 sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE with Color 3. Knit 2 rows.

*Put the center needle into holding position, knit 6 rows. All needles in work, knit 2 rows. REPEAT FROM * for as long as you need to go around edge of cover.

PILLOW:

Cast on 133 sts. with color 1 and work the Weaving Design to Row 322. Bind off.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

THE CROCHET BIND OFF

The crochet method for binding off on the main machine is very simple and you can use this method on ANY knitting machine without the Ribber.

When you have completed a section, knit 1 row with a tension setting AT LEAST 4 numbers higher than the tension you used for knitting your garment. Now bring all the needles into holding position and with your latch tool, begin at the end OPPO-SITE the yarn end. Take the first stitch off the machine needle onto the latch tool and allow it to go behind the latch. Remove the 2nd stitch and pull it through the stitch on the latch tool, then allow this stitch to go behind the latch of tool.. Continue in this manner until the last stitch has been removed. Pull the end of yarn through the last stitch on tool to secure the knitting.

If you cannot turn your tension up at least 4 numbers, you must knit this last row by hand as follows: Bring the needles into "D" position and make sure the latches are open. Place the yarn across the open latches and knit each stitch by hand, leaving each stitch in the hooks of the needles and making a long loop. Do not allow the previous stitch to pull forward (toward you)... hold it with your hand so that the loops are all uniform. When you have worked across the needles, hold down on the knitting as you bring the needles into holding position and the stitches go behind the latches. Now complete your bind off as given above.

BIND OFF THE CROCHET METHOD FOR RIBBING

Many of the Patterns in KNITKING MAGAZINE state "bind off the crochet method for Ribbing"... and this is the way to do it:

For the 830 and other Japanese made Ribbing Attach ments... When you are ready to bind off, set the Knitter Tension Control to 10 and the Ribber Tension Control to 8. Knit 1 row. Transfer the Ribber sts. to the knitter, lower the Ribbing Attachment, then bind off beginning OPPOSITE the yarn end using the same method as given for the Knitter bind off.

If you are using heavy weight yarn and you cannot turn the tension numbers up at least 4 numbers, you must then knit this last row BY HAND, taking first a knitter stitch then a Ribber stitch. After all the stitches have been knit by hand, transfer the Ribber stitches to knitter and bind off the same crochet method.
