

Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1 means decrease (or increase) st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of in-crease. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang

it onto the empty needle.

3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only I set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5xl above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

above the needle bed.

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts . Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this... Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. fou will cast on 124 sts. for the first size.

Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size. Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 2 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move

the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and

hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew l edge to the inside and l to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew l edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.







FINISHING: See General Instructions. Pullover Collar: Sew back seam then sew 1 edge to neckline using 78 sts. for the back neck and 104 sts. for the front neck ege. Fold in half to the outside. CAP: Sew back seam if you knitted it flat. Pull top sts. together and secure. Roll lower edge of Cap (see picture).









ROLL COLLAR:

Cast on 182 sts. with color 1 and work the Ribbing same as you did for front and back except that you must use a larger tension for 50 rows, then smaller tension for 26 rows. Remove onto waste yarn (or bind off loosely).

CAP: Use Tension 6 to 8

Cast on 130 sts. and work flat (or you can do circular knitting using the Ribber). Knit Stockinette stitch for 110 rows. Mark every 25th and 26th st. then decrease 1 st. before and after each marked stitch every 3rd row 4x, then every row until 10 sts. remain. Remove onto end of yarn and pull up.

FRONT: I


Cast on 130 (134) [140] sts. with color 1 and work K2, P2 (or K1, P1) Ribbing to Row 40. Transfer the Ribber sts. to main machine and work the 7 rows of Norwegian Design as shown on the Chart. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1. Knit to Row 148 (148) [152]. Continue in the Norwegian Design as shown on the Chart. After Row 158 (158) [162], SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x]. When Norwegian Design is completed, continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1. After Row 220 (220) [226], SHAPE NECK: Put half the sts. on the lef into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, st. 6x. 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, st. 7x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, st. 7x]. After Row 238 (238) [246] SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off 6 sts. 5x. (6 sts. 4x, 8 sts. [7 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x]. Bring the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 220 (220) [226] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

BACK: II

Cast on 130 (138) [144] sts. Work the back the same as the fron to Row 158 (158) [162] then SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the front an knit to Row 238 (238) [246]. SHAPE SHOULDER SAME AS THE FRONT b AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 242 (2 [250], SHAPE NECK: Put half the s on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 14 (15) [15] sts. lx, 4 sts. 2x for all sizes.





FOR SHOULDER, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 4x, 8 sts. 1x; (7 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x); [6 sts. 6x]; AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 254 (258) [258], Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 15 (15) [16] sts. 1x, 4 sts. 2x for all sizes. Bring the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 254 (258) [258] and complete the left half. Follow the Instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.








Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 200 (212) [212] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.





Cast on 37 sts. with color 1 and work in Pattern.

ON THE RIGHT (left for 2nd section), cast on 2 sts. 15x, 1 st. 3x. After Row 32, ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 9th row 7x. After Row 96, SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x, then on every 2nd row, increase 1 st. 8x. After Row 121, SHAPE NECK: Bind off 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 2x, and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 144. Work the 2nd section with reverse shaping.

BACK: II

Cast on 74 sts. with color 1 and work in WEAVING PATTERN, with REPEATED COLOR STRIPES of 4 ROWS with color 2, 3, and 4. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 9th row 7x. After Row 64, SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. lx, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. lx, 1 st. 1x, then ON EVERY 2nd row, increase 1 st. 8x. After Row 112, SHAPE SHOULDER and SHAPE NECK; Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *FOR SHOULDER, bind off 6 sts. 4x, and FOR NECK: bind off 5 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit I row in pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 112 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

ARMBANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 72 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.
After Row 12, remove onto contrast waste yarn.

NECKBAND: Cast on 110 sts. with color 1 and work 12 rows Stockinette stitch. Remove onto waste yarn.

FRONT BANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 80 sts. with color 1 and work the same as armbands.

LOWER BAND: 1 piece for fronts and back.

Cast on 122 sts. with color 1 and work same as armbands.





COVERLET & PILLOWS

SIZE: Coverlet - 62" x 104" (approx)
YARN: Euro Sport

GRAMS: COVERLET (or Bedspread)
color 1 500

color 3 500 color 3 500 color 4 500

For 2 Pillows, add 3 more balls. TENSION: 8 or 9

GAUGE:12 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Tuck Stitch Pattern. Punch your own Card.

FINISHING: Bedspread, - Sew sections together (see Picture) so that sections form chevrons. Work single crochet around edges or finish edges with trim of your choice.
CIRCULAR PILLOW: Sew sections together (8 for each side) then sew over a pillow form, or you can make separate pillow and stuff with fiber fill. Sew around pillow sections leaving open enough to push separate pillow inside, then close opening. Make pom-pom or button and sew to centers.

OBLONG PILLOW: - Sew sections together. Make separate pillow to


pillow then close openings.

BEDSPREAD: Make 3 sections of EACH COLOR and reverse card so that sections will form chevrons -

fit cover - sew seams and insert

Cast on 50 sts. and work in Pattern to Row 720. Bind off.


ROUND PILLOW: Make 16 sections (4 of each color).

Cast on 40 sts. and work in Pattern. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 9x, every 6th row 9x.

After Row 96, bind off


OBLONG PILLOW: Make 2 sections each color.

Cast on 28 sts. and work in Pattern. After Row 180, bind off.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

RIBBING WITH HEAVY YARNS

When ribbing with heavier yarns such as Binia or Euro Sport, be sure to thoroughly wax the yarn. Hold a piece of ordinary paraffin wax in your hand and allow the yarn to run over it as you wind the yarn into a pull ball. Use EVERY OTHER NEEDLE on the main machine and EVERY OTHER NEEDLE on the ribber.

RIBBED BANDS

Sometimes in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we tell you to remove ribbed bands onto contrast waste yarn. To make it easy for you to sew or weave these open stitches to a neckline or armhole, you can always knit 4 rows of stockinette stitch ON EACH BED first, then remove the stitches onto the waste yarn. When you are ready to sew the bands onto the garment, one edge of the stockinette stitch must be sewn to the inside and one to the outside of the garment. If you do not like to weave or sew open stitches, you can bind off the band stitches using the crochet method.

STITCH GAUGE STRIPS FOR USE WITH THE KNITLEADER ON THE JUMBO ${\rm CN-9}$

We now have a set of 2 strips to use with your KNITLEADER on the JUMBO CN-9. There are 4 sets of measurements on each strip for a total of 8. The measurements are 9.1 cm, 9.5 cm, 10.0 cm, 10.5 cm, 11.1 cm, 11.8 cm, 12.5 cm and 13.3 cm.

In order for you to use your KNITLEADER, you should make your sample swatch as follows and use knitting worsted weight yarn.

With waste yarn, cast on 30 sts. Knit 10 rows. Change to the yarn you want to use for garment and set Counter at 0. Knit 15 rows, mark the 5th st. ON EACH SIDE by knitting it with a piece of contrast. Knit 15 more rows, then knit 10 rows with waste yarn. Be sure to use the same weight of yarn for the contrast. Remove the swatch from the machine. Pull the sample into shape and allow it to rest for several hours or overnight. If it is wool, you can steam it. You can also wash the sample and allow it to dry thoroughly. This is especially good if it is a synthetic.

With the ruler that comes with your KNITLEADER, measure the 20 stitches between the markers. Let us suppose it measures 12.5 cm. Take the strip with the marking of 12.5 and check your sample against it by folding the knitting over at the marked row and placing the sample between the markings on the strip beginning at the center dotted line on the strip across to 20 sts. It should match with the ruler measurement of 12.5. This is the strip you will place on the KNITLEADER.

With your ruler, measure the 30 rows. Supposing it measures 14.5 cm which is 145 mm. Set the regulator on the KNITLEADER to 14 for the cm, then set the mm regulator to 5.

The TRIP for the movement of the KNITLEADER SHEET must move two times on every row. If you have

two Row Counter trips, one on each side of the Carriage, it will automatically trip twice, but if you do not have two Row Counter trips, you will have to move this trip the second time by hand.

This information is only a supplement to the Instruction Book which you received with your KNITLEADER. The set of 2 strips is \$1.50 plus 90¢ shipping costs.

SLIPPERS - Knitting Worsted Weight. Approx. 2 1/2 oz.

No telling how many thousand pairs of these have been made since the instructions were printed in KNITKING MAGAZINE some years ago. We are updating them so you can knit them on any Punch Card machine.

Punch your card with a REPEAT of the two rows shown - long enough so the card will revolve when clipped together. EVERY 3rd NEEDLE is used and to find the exact needles you must use for the Card to work, begin as follows: Bring 60 needles into working position (every needle). Set your card and push in BOTH TUCK BUTTONS. Run the carriage across. Bring all the needles that set into pattern into holding position. Set the Cam Control to holding and run the carriage for the 2nd row. Bring the needles that set into pattern into holding position again. Return the holding Cam Control to knit. You will see that you have EVERY 3rd needle in holding position. Push all remaining needles into working position and use them as a guide for casting on over EVERY 3rd needle.

SIZES: Small (Medium) [Large] Tension 9 or 10. 22 rows]5cm

Cast on 33 (37) [41] sts. over EVERY 3rd NEEDLE. (See above information). Knit in TUCK PATTERN to Row 100 (112) [124]. Bring all the needles into working position and knit 1 very loose row by hand - be sure each loop is at least 1/4" long. Bind off the crochet method.

FINISHING: Pull the knitting into a square shape. Pull up the cast on edge. With purl side inside, fold the square into a triangle and pin with large pins. Thread a tapestry needle with yarn and over-cast, beginning at the folded point (toe) and rounding the last few stitches at end to form heel. Continue to sew up the instep for 3 or 3 1/2". Turn to the right side and sew bell to tip of toe then fold toe up about 1" and fasten. Fold the cuff to the right side. Make tassel in a contrast color and attach to point of cuff (see picture). For tassel, wind yarn around 4 fingers approximately 16 times. Tie through loop. Fold with tie at top then tie yarn about 1/2" from top of tassel. Pull ends through to hide them. Cut bottom of tassel. To make slippers larger or smaller, change the size of square according to your stitch and row gauge.
