
 Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.


 3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

 Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.






General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1

6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.

Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.

Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

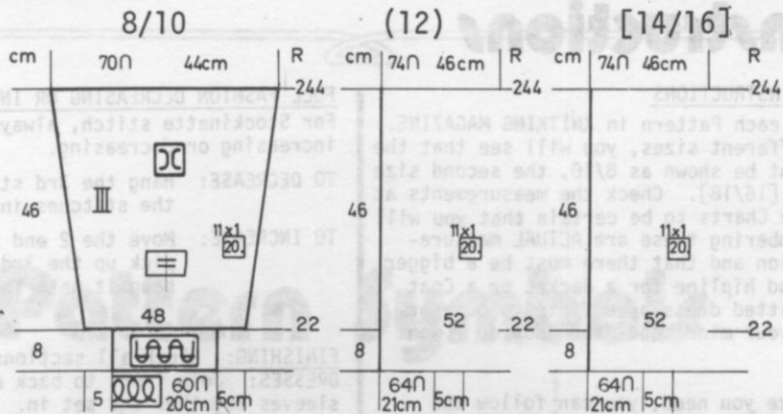
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WOMAN'S JACKET

SIZES: 8/10 (12) [14/16]
 YARN: Crocus Crepe
 GRAMS: 600 650 700
 TENSION: 8 to 10
 GAUGE: Pattern, OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE - 8 sts. 25 rows = 5 cm

A Tuck Stitch Pattern over every other needle. Punch your own Card. The bands are ribbed.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. After sewing the shoulder seams, Pick up sts. along 1 front edge around to center of back - EVERY OTHER NEEDLE. Work 12 rows in Tuck Pattern. To bind off, put the first stitch onto 2nd needle and pull through 2nd st, bind off and continue in this way until all sts. are bound off. Repeat for other side. Sew center back seam of band, then work 1 row REVERSE single crochet around edges of band. Make a cord using 6 strands of yarn then pull through first pattern row at waist and tie.



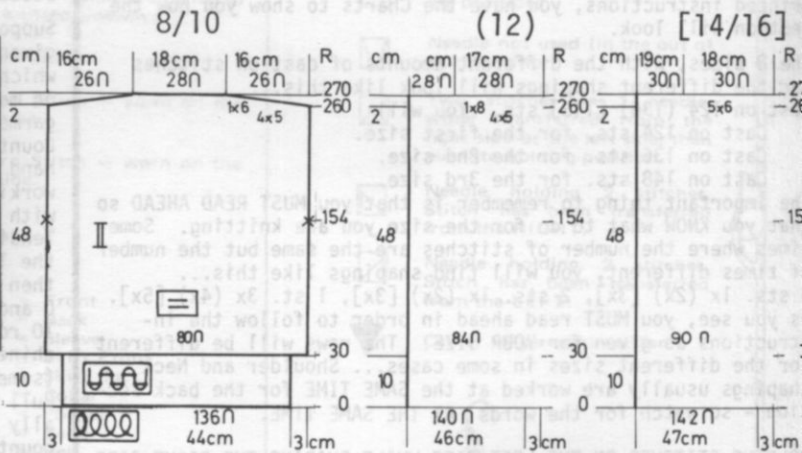
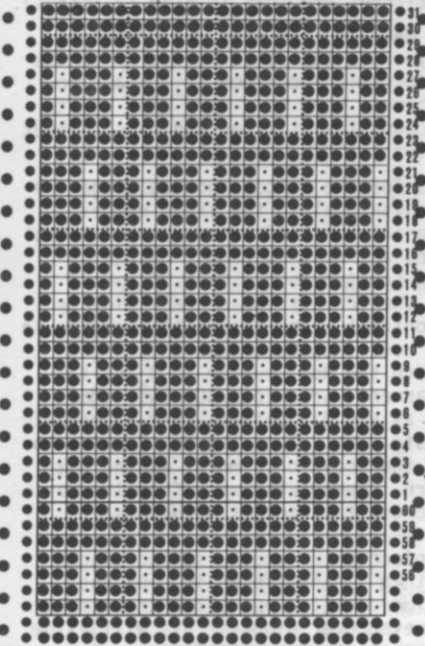
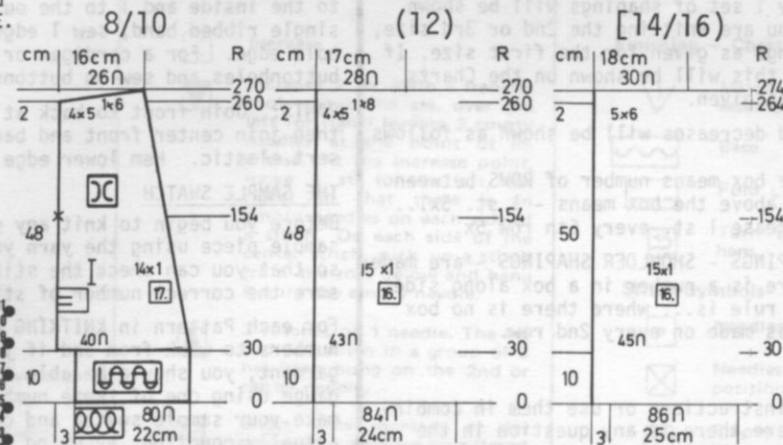
SLEEVES: III

Cast on 60 (64) [64] sts. and work 22 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Transfer the ribber sts. and DECREASE 12 sts. evenly across and SET FOR PATTERN same as you did for the back using every other needle. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 20th row 11x. After Row 244, bind off.

FRONT: I Make 1, reverse I

Cast on 80 (84) [86] sts. and work 30 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Transfer the ribber sts. then DECREASE 40 (41) [41] sts. evenly across and set up for Pattern same as you did for Back over EVERY OTHER NEEDLE. ON FRONT EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 17th row 14x. (every 16th row 15x). [every 16th row 15x]. After Row 154, mark side ed. for setting in sleeve then Knit to Row 261 (261) [265] SHAPE SHOULDER, bind off 5 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x. (5 sts. 4x, 8 sts. 1x). [6 sts. 5x].

FRONT & NECK BANDS, See FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS.



BACK: II

Cast on 136 (140) [142] sts. and work 30 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Transfer the ribber sts. to main machine then DECREASE 56 (56) [52] sts. across and set for PATTERN USING EVERY OTHER NEEDLE - Always be sure to use the FIRST NEEDLE TO THE LEFT OF 0 then every other needle on each side.

Continue in Pattern. Mark Row 154 for setting in sleeve then knit to Row 260. SHAPE SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x. (5 sts. 4x, 8 sts. 1x). [6 sts. 5x]. After Row 270, bind off the remaining sts.

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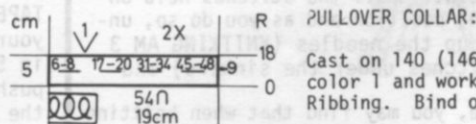
WOMAN'S PULLOVER & JACKET

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16]
 YARN: Crocus Crepe
 GRAMS: color 1 750 800 850 color 2 400 450 500
 TENSION: 8 to 10
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 13 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Norwegian Design using two Cards. Be sure to reverse the Cards when knitting the second half of fronts and the second sleeve. The bands are ribbed.

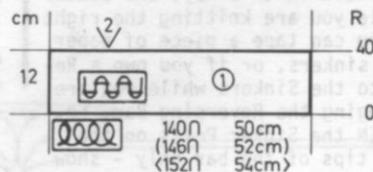


FINISHING: See General Instructions. Finish Buttonholes & sew on Buttons.



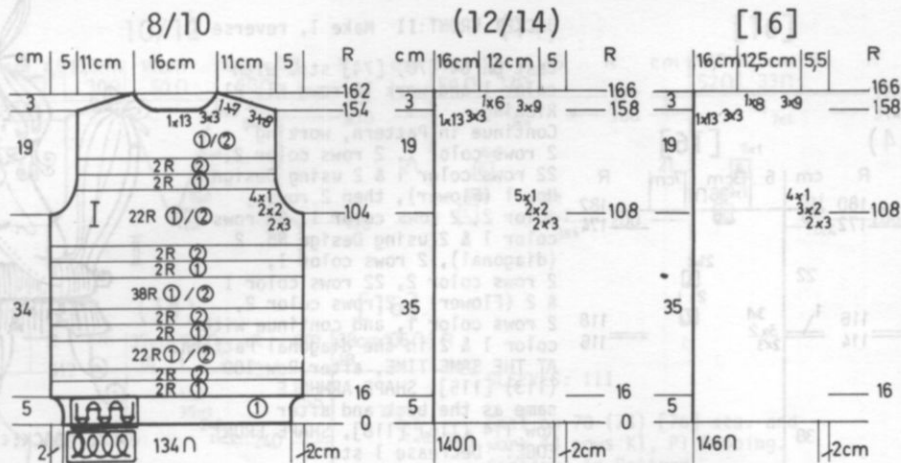
PULLOVER COLLAR:

Cast on 140 (146) [152] sts. with color 1 and work 40 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off.

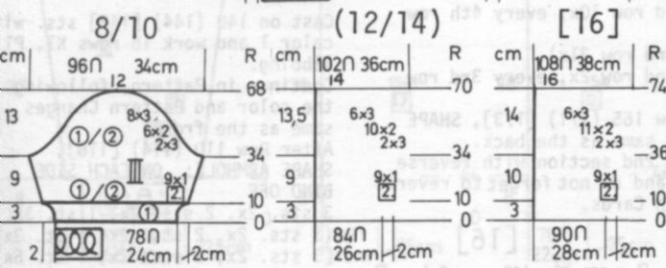


PULLOVER FRONT BANDS: Make 2.

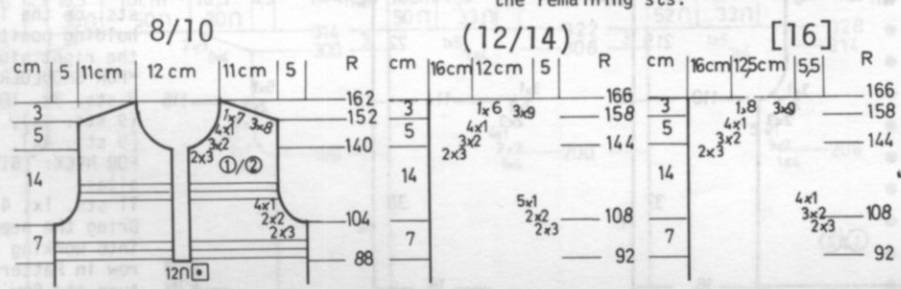
Cast on 54 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. After Row 9, make BUTTONHOLES over needles 6 to 8, 17 to 20, 31 to 34, 45 to 48. After Row 18, bind off. Work the 2nd band the same but OMitting Buttonholes.



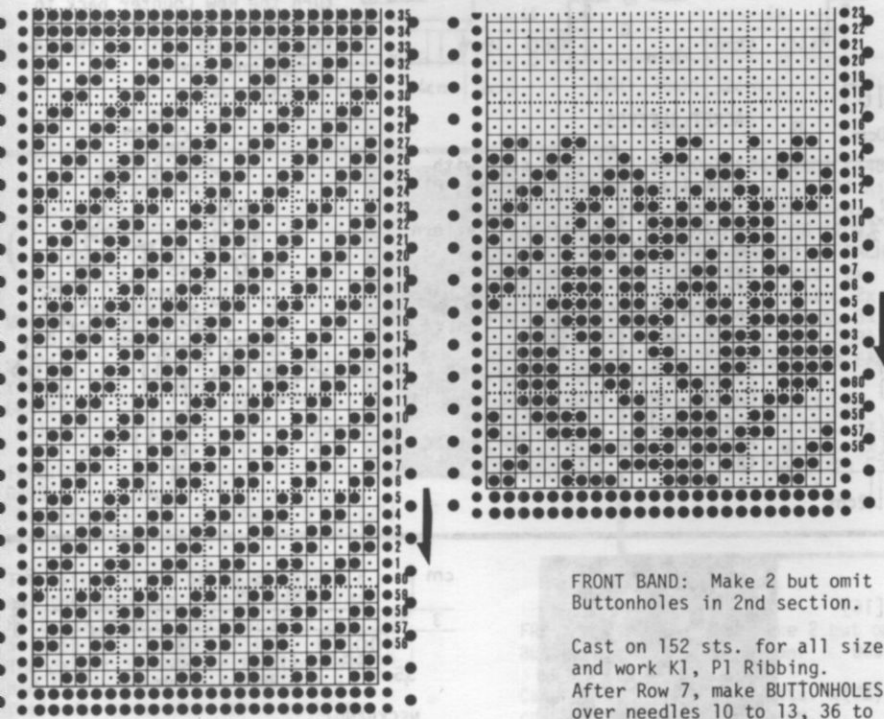
PULLOVER BACK: I
 Cast on 134 (140) [146] sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
 Continue in Pattern. Work 2 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2 then 22 rows Norwegian Design 1 (Flower), 2 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2, 38 rows Norwegian Design 2 (Diagonal) etc.. Follow the Chart for Pattern and color remembering that 22 rows are always Design No. 1 (flower) and the 38 rows Design No. 2 (diagonal).
 After Row 104 (108) [108], SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x].
 After Row 154 (158) [158], SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.



PULLOVER SLEEVES: III
 Cast on 78 (84) [90] sts. with color 1 and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
 Continue in the Diagonal Pattern.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 2nd row 9x.
 After Row 34 (34) [36], SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 6x, 3 sts. 8x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 10x, 3 sts. 6x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 11x, 3 sts. 6x].
 After Row 68 (70) [74], bind off the remaining sts.



PULLOVER FRONT: II
 Work the front the same as the back, following the same pattern sequence throughout.
 After Row 88 (92) [92], bind off the center 12 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *Knit to Row 104 (108) [108]. SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back then knit to Row 141 (145) [145].
 SHAPE NECK: Bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x for all sizes.
 After Row 152 (158) [158], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 88 (92) [92] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



COLLAR: Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 96, (100) [104] and work K1, P1 Ribbing.
 After Row 14, work SHORT ROWS.
 ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF SLIDE, put into holding position
 3 sts. 12x, 4 sts. 6x.
 (3 sts. 12x, 4 sts. 7x).
 [3 sts. 12x, 4 sts. 8x].
 After Row 50 (52) [54], bind off.

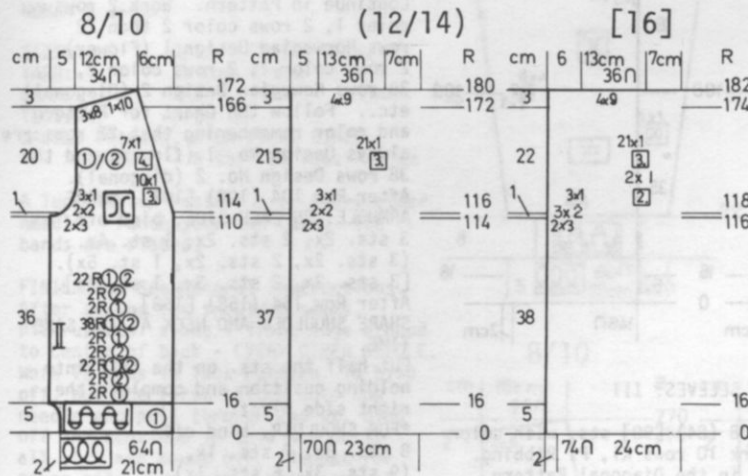
FRONT BAND: Make 2 but omit Buttonholes in 2nd section.

Cast on 152 sts. for all sizes and work K1, P1 Ribbing.
 After Row 7, make BUTTONHOLES over needles 10 to 13, 36 to 39, 62 to 65, 88 to 91, 113 to 116, 131 to 135 counting from the left edge. Knit to Row 14, then bind off.

Sew Collar sections together at back, then sew narrow ends to bands.
 Sew in place on Jacket.

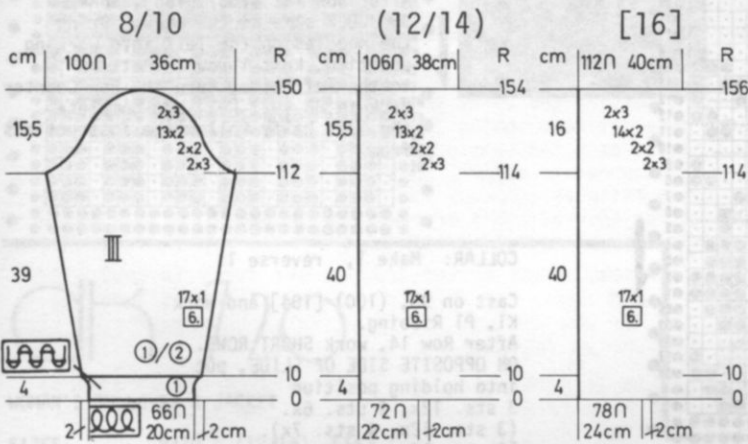
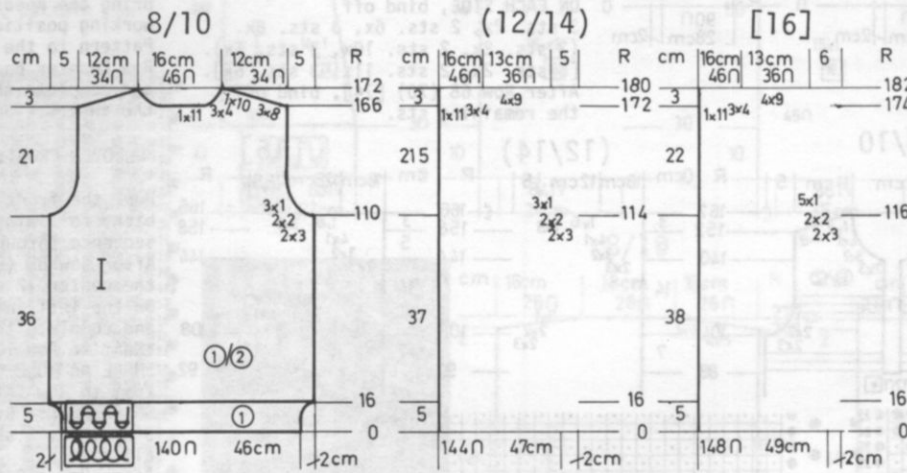
JACKET FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 64 (70) [74] sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
Continue in Pattern, working 2 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2, 22 rows color 1 & 2 using Design No. 1 (Flower), then 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 1, 38 rows color 1 & 2 using Design No. 2 (diagonal), 2 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2, 22 rows color 1 & 2 (Flower), 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 1, and continue with color 1 & 2 in the diagonal Pattern.
AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 109 (113) [115], SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back and after Row 114 (116) [118], SHAPE FRONT EDGE: Decrease 1 st. every 3rd row 10x, every 4th row 7x.
(every 3rd row 21x).
[every 2nd row 2x, every 3rd row 21x].
After Row 165 (171) [173], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
Make the 2nd section with reverse shaping and do not forget to reverse the Punch Cards.



JACKET BACK: I

Cast on 140 (144) [148] sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
Continue in Pattern, following the color and Pattern Changes same as the front.
After Row 110 (114) [116], SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE BIND OFF 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x) [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x] Knit to Row 166 (172) [174]. SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. Put half the sts. on the left side into holding position and complete the right side first.
*FOR SHOULDER, bind off 8 sts. 3x, 10 sts. 1x, (9 sts. 4x), [9 sts. 4x],
FOR NECK: Bind off for all sizes.
11 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 3x.
Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side turn the Row Counter back to 166 (172) [174] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



JACKET SLEEVES:

Cast on 66 (72) [78] sts. with color 1 and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
Continue in the Diagonal Pattern. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 17x.
After Row 112 (114) [114], SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 13x, 3 sts. 2x.
(Same as first size).
[3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 14x, 2 sts. 3x].
After Row 150 (154) [156], bind off the remaining sts.



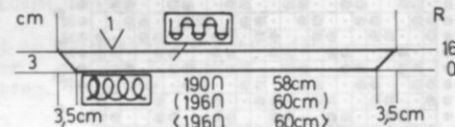

A Tuck Stitch Pattern worn on the Purl side. Punch your own Card and push in BOTH TUCK BUTTONS. Bands are ribbed.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.

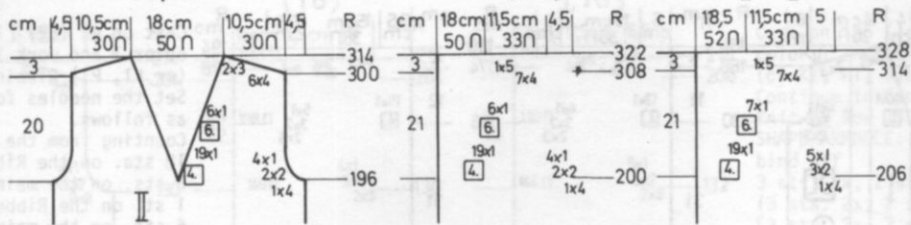
Cast on 190 (196) [196] sts. and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. every 2nd row 7x.

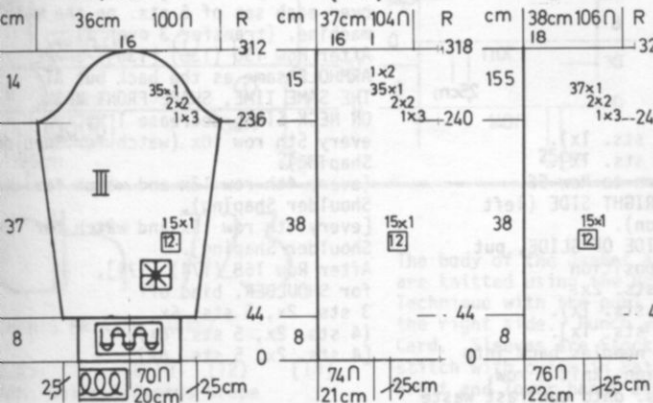

ON NECK SIDE, bind off 1 st. every 4th row 19x, every 6th row 6x. (Same as first size). [1 st. every 4th row 19x, every 6th row 7x]. After Row 300 (308) [314], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 196 (200) [206] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

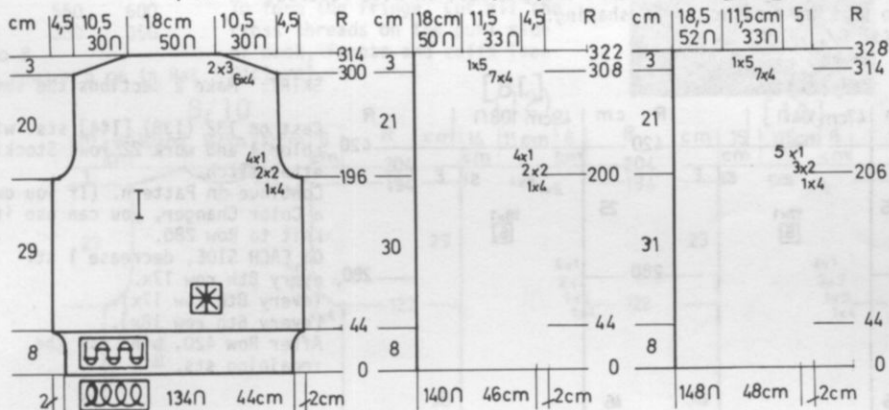

After Row 312 (318) [320], bind off the remaining sts.

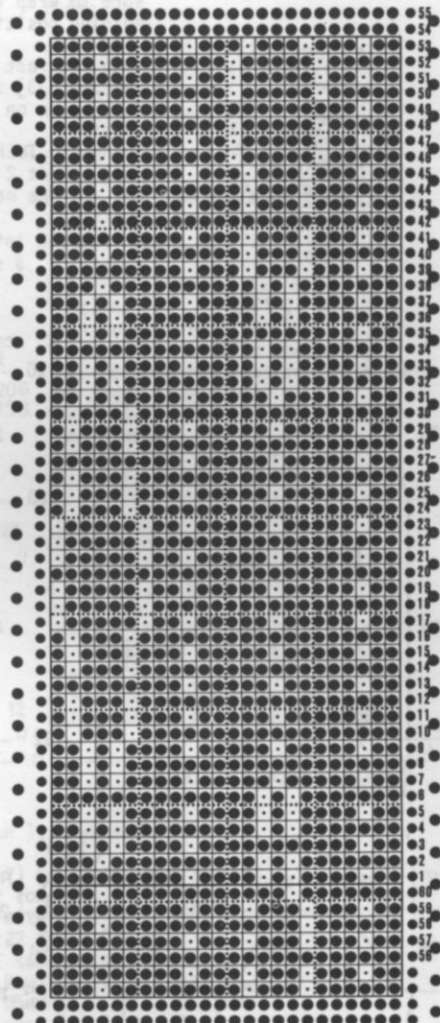

(4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x). [4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x]. Knit to Row 300 (308) [314]. SHAPE SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 6x, 3 sts. 2x. (4 sts. 7x, 5 sts. 1x). [4 sts. 7x, 5 sts. 1x]. After Row 314 (322) [328], bind off the remaining sts.

 10 rows color 1

Knit to Row 156 (164) [178]. Continue in K2, P2 Ribbing to Row 186 (194) [208]. Bind off. Hang the open sts. back onto the machine, decreasing to 56 sts. Knit 1 row Stockinette stitch then continue in K2, P2 Ribbing for 30 rows. Bind off.

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KNITTING NEWS

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

WHAT SIZE DO YOU WEAR?

Wouldn't we all like to be a perfect size 8, 10 or 12...? but most of us fall short of a perfect size and perhaps we hesitate to knit a lovely garment in KNITTING MAGAZINE because the sizes given are NOT OUR SIZE... Take heart... you CAN knit most of the garments in any size you need. You CAN change the instructions so that if you are a size 16 or 18 and the size given is 10/12 or 14 ... and it really is not that much of a problem to make the garment fit you.

As you must know, knitted garments should never fit tightly and the amount of ease depends on the STYLE and the yarn you use. An outer garment such as a Coat, Jacket, a Pullover worn over a Blouse, Vest, etc. should always have more ease allowance than a softly fitted dress for instance.

There are several ways to change the size of a garment. If you add or subtract 1" of stitches to the cast on for the front and 1" of stitches to the back, you have added 2" in width (or subtracted 2") and if the gauge is given as 16 sts. to 5 cm (2"), you add 8 sts. to the front and 8 sts. to the back. Check the width at the underarm. It is very possible, you can just follow the armhole bind offs as given, but if the width after the armhole bind off is too much (or too little), take half of the 8 sts. and bind off 2 extra sts. on each side with the first bind off. Divide the remaining sts. for binding off at the shoulders and neckline - 1 st. for each shoulder and 2 sts. at neck. A good thing to remember however, when the garment is in a Pattern Stitch, try to add or subtract either a complete pattern or half a pattern so that you can match the side seams.

ROWS: - you can wear a size 8 and be 6 feet tall or you can be 4 feet tall. A size 18 or 20 can be very short or very tall and so you must check the complete length of any garment. You may have to add or subtract rows. Always try to add or subtract rows at intervals where there is no shaping. Change the row numbers accordingly on your pattern chart. Put in your own row numbers or you can knit the number of rows you need then turn the Row Counter to the number shown on the Chart so that you will not be confused.

If you are not sure what size you should knit, take a garment that fits you well and that you enjoy wearing and use the measurements from it as a guide.... HAPPY KNITTING.
