Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1 means decrease (or increase) st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of in-crease. At the increase point, 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1 6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x...

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

above the needle bed.

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts . Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size. Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size. Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 2 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew l edge to the inside and l to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew l edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row. gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")


If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16/18]
YARN: Vienna
GRAMS: 200 250 300
TENSION: 4 to 7
GAUGE:15 sts.18 1/2 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Lace Pattern. Punch your own Card. The bands are Stockinette stitch.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Work 1 row single crochet around neck slit then 1 row with chains for buttonholes on the right side. Sew Buttons on left side of slit. (See picture).



FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 188 (192) [196]. SHAPE ARMHOLES same as the back and after Row 228 (232) [236] Divide in the center, put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

**ON NECK SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x. (7 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x). [8 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x]. After Row 258 (266) [274], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 228 (232) [236] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from **.






Sew 1 shoulder seam them pick up the sts. around neck - 148 (152) [152] sts. and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. Hang the hem and bind off or you can bind off and turn hem to the inside and sew in place.

ARMBANDS: Pick up 108 (112) [116] sts. and work 16 rows Stockinette and complete same as Neckband.

BACK: II

Cast on 138 (150) [162] sts. and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. Hang the hem, then continue in Pattern.
Knit to Row 188 (192) [196].
SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x, then 1 st. every 4th row 19x.
(4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x, then 1 st. every 4th row 19x).
[3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x, then 1 st. every 4th row 19x].
After Row 258 (266) [274], bind off the center 38 (44) [44] sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.
FOR SHOULDER, bind off 6 sts. 2x
(8 sts. 1x, 7 sts. 1x).
[9 sts. 2x].
FOR NECK, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 1 st. 2x.
(4 sts. 1x, 1 sts. 2x).
[6 sts. 1x, 1 sts. 2x).
Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 258 (266) [274] and complete the left half. Follow the

SIZES: 10/12 (14)
YARN: Nomotta Viola (No Kit available) or use any yarn that gives stitch & Row Gauge.

GRAMS:

GAUGE: 12 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")


Color Stripes with an Intarsia Design on front and back sections. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.

NOTE: Follow the Chart for the Intarsia Design with stripes of 14 rows color 1, 8 rows color 3. Change colors as shown on the Chart. Begin with 3 balls of yarn. After Row 66, work with 4 balls and after Row 114 work with 5 balls. Be sure to cross the yarns when changing colors and move 1 st. over on every row as shown.

FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 186 (194).
SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back but after Row 230 (238) bind off the center 30 (30) sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
**ON NECK SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 3x, 1 st. every 4th row 4x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x, then 1 st. every 4th row 3x).
After Row 262 (270), SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 230 (238) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.





NECKBAND: Sew 1 shoulder first.


Pick up 120 (126) sts. around the neck and work 10 rows Ribbing. Bind off.


ARMBANDS:

Pick up 128 (132) sts. around armhole and work 10 rows Ribbing. Bind off.

BACK: II

Cast on 118 (128) sts. with color 1 and work 20 rows Ribbing.
Continue in Pattern with color stripes as shown on the chart and be sure to read NOTE above.
After Row 114, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 20th row 3x.
After Row 186 (194), SHAPE ARMHOLE:
ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x then 1 st. every 6th row 10x for both sizes.
After Row 254 (262) bind off the center 34 (38) sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
*ON NECK SIDE, bind off for both sizes
4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x and after Row 262 (270) SHAPE SHOULDER by binding off 5 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x.
(6 sts. 2x).
Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 254 (262) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *,





WOMAN'S DRESS

SIZES: 7/8 YARN: Nomotta Viola (No Kit available) or use any yarn that gives stitch & Row Gauge. GRAMS :

450 = Rose color 1 150 = Lt. Blue 100 = Yellow 150 color 2 100 color 3 100 100 = Natural TENSION: 8 or 9

GAUGE:12 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with color stripes. Lower edge of dress is K1, P1 Ribbing. Neck and Arm Bands are Garter stitch worked on hand knitting needles - or you can make the bands on the machine in Stockinette stitch and use the purl side as the right side of bands.


FINISHING: See General Instructions.

RIGHT FRONT: I

Cast on 64 sts. with color 1 and work 20 rows Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch. ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. ON SIDE EDGE, decrease I st.
every 12th row 6x, every 8th row
2x, every 6th row 2x for both sizes.
After Row 126, begin the color stripes.
*2 rows Color 2, 2 rows color 3
REPEAT from * for 22 rows in all.
Work 16 rows color 1 then
work 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 4 and REPEAT for 22 rows in all. Work 16 rows color l then REPEAT from * until there are 5 sets of stripes with alternating COIOrs.
AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 252 (260)
SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off
4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st.
3x, then 1 st. every 3rd row 12x,
1 st. every 4th row 5x
BUT AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 303,
SHAPE NECK: ON NECK SIDE, bind off
6 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x,
1 st. 5x and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 322 by binding off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x. 3 sts. lx, 2 sts. lx.
(5 sts. lx, 3 sts. lx, 2 sts. 2x,
l st. 4x, l st. every 3rd row l2x,
l st. every 4th row 5x BUT AT THE
SAME TIME after Row 31l, SHAPE NECK:
ON NECK SIDE, bind off 8 sts. lx,
3 sts. lx, 2 sts. 2x, l st. 5x
and after Row 330, SHAPE SHOULDER
by binding off 3 sts. lx, 2 sts. lx).

WORK THE LEFT FRONT in the same way but have Counter at 0 on the left side and BEGIN THE COLOR STRIPES after Row 28 and have only 3 sets of color stripes then continue with color 1 only. Work all shapings the same.





BACK: II

Sew 1 shoulder first, then pick up 90 sts. around neckline with hand knitting needles and work 5 rows garter stitch - or finish in any



NECKBAND:

Pick up 114 sts. and work same as for the Neckband.

Work the BACK sections (2) exactly Work the BACK sections (2) exactly the same as the front sections except for the NECK SHAPING.
Mark Row 272 (280) for center seam (and sew back seam to these markers). FOR THE NECK SHAPING, after Row 321 (329), bind off 15 (17) sts. then bind off 3 sts. lx for both sizes. Work Shoulder same as the front after Row 322 (330). Sew the two back sections together up to the marked Row. Work 1 row single crochet around neck opening. single crochet around neck opening Make chain loops for buttonholes and sew buttons to other side.

SIZES: 8/10 (12) YARN: Vienna

GRAMS:

color 1 200 250

color 2 100 100

Small amounts of different

colors for embroidery not included in Kit. TENSION: 4 to 7 GAUGE:15 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with Intarsia on the Front section. Bands are Garter stitch worked on hand knitting needles or you can pick up the sts. and work Kl, Pl Ribbing on the machine.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Work 1 row single crochet down back neck opening making chain loop for buttonhole. Sew Button to left side. Embroider the Butterfly on front section. See Picture.

FRONT: I

Cast on 140 (150) sts. with color 2 and work 12 rows of K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 2 and ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 12th row 3x for both sizes.

After Row 58 (62) begin the INTARSIA Design. Start with 2 sts. in color 1 and ON EVERY ROW, work 1 more stitch in color 1, crossing the yarns when changing color to prevent a hole.

After Row 150 (158) SHAPE ARMHOLE. ON EACH SIDE, bind offf 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x for both sizes.


After Row 200 (208), bind off the center 14 (16) sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x, 1 st. every 4th row 4x for both sizes.

After Row 226 (234), SHAPE SHOULDER. Bind off 10 sts. 3x. (10 sts. 1x, 12 sts. 2x).

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 200 (208) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




BACK: II

Work the back the same as the front EXCEPT begin with color 1 and after Row 58, (62) start with the 2 sts. in color 2. Work in the same way to Row 150 (158). SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the front and after Row 192 (200) divide in the center. Put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*After Row 220 (228) SHAPE NECK.
ON NECK SIDE, bind off 16 (17) sts. 1x, then bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x for both sizes and after Row 226 (234) SHAPE SHOULDER same as the front.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 192 (200) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.





NECKBAND:

With color 1, cast on 120 (126) sts. and work 6 rows of Ribbing - or you can pick up the sts. and work Garter Stitch with hand knitting needles. Bind off.

ARMBANDS:

Work the right armband in color 1 and left with color 2. Cast on 107 (113) sts. and work same as for the Neckband.







SIZES: 40 (42)
YARN: Vienna
GRAMS:
color 1 300 350
color 2 50 50
TENSION: 4 to 7
GAUGE:15 sts. 19 1/2 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch and stripes with a TUCK Stitch Pattern for upper section and sleeves. Bands are Kl, Pl Ribbing. Punch your own

card and push the marked needles (every 6th & 8th) to the OUT OF WORK POSITION. Push in 1 Tuck Button only.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



REPEAT Punch Card through Row 35 then punch 2 rows of holes for connecting Card. Set the marked needles OUT OF WORK. Push in ONLY 1 TUCK BUTTON for Pattern.


BACK: II

Cast on 156 (168) sts. with color 1 and work 22 rows Ribbing.
Continue in Stripe Pattern of 14 rows Color 1, 2 rows Color 2.
After Row 148 (156), continue in TUCK PATTERN with color 1.
After Row 156 (164), SHAPE ARMHOLE:
ON EACH SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x for both sizes.
After Row 232 (244) SHAPE SHOULDER and WATCH FOR NECK SHAPING.
FOR SHOULDER, bind off ON EACH SIDE, 7 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 1x.
(7 sts. 4x, 8 sts. 1x).


AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 240 (252), bind off the center 38 (44) sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

Stockinette stitch with an INTARSIA DESIGN. Bands are Stockinette stitch.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Turn sleeve bands to inside and hem. Sew on neck facing and turn to the inside and sew in place. Fold and make hem at lower edge.



IMPORTANT NOTE
When knitting the Back section,
colors numbered in circles 0
are used. When knitting the front,
colors numbered without circles such
as 2 - are used. Be sure when changing colors for the INTARSIA that you
twist the colors to prevent a hole
in your knitting.

NECK FACING: Make 2


Cast on 44 (46) sts. and work 10 rows Stockinette stitch. Bind off or remove onto waste yarn.

BACK & FRONT: 1/II - Both sections are the same except for changes in Cast on 40 (40) sts. with color 2 and work 12 rows Stockinette stitch. Continue in the INTARSIA Design beginning with 20 sts. for each ON EVERY ROW, move the colors over 1 st. as shown on the Chart. Follow the Chart throughout for the Design and color changes. After Row 44, ON SHOULDER SIDE increase 1 st. every 6th row 15x and AT THE SAME TIME, After Row 76 (80) SHAPE UNDERARM. PLEASE FOLLOW THE CHART FOR THIS SHAPING IN THE SIZE YOU NEED. After Row 204 (214) SHAPE NECK. ON NECK SIDE, decrease (or bind off) 2 sts. 21x (22x).

After Row 246 (260) ON NECK SIDE, increase 2 sts. 21x (22x).

After Row 333 (353) Bind off 45 (51) sts. then continue the UNDERARM SHAPING IN REVERSE. After Row 358 (386) ON SHOULDER SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 15x. After Row 480 (508) work 12 rows Stockinette stitch with



FRONT: I Make 1, Reverse 1.
Make Pocket Linings first.
For the Pocket Lining, cast on 22 sts. with color 1 and work 18 rows in Pattern. Remove onto a stitch holder. Make 2.
FOR THE FRONT, cast on 37 (42) sts. with color 2 and work 16 Rows Stockinette stitch.
Continue in Pattern with color


After Row 36. counting from the side edge, skip 3 sts., them remove the next 22 sts. onto a stitch holder. Hang the pocket lining sts. onto the empty needles and continue in pattern. (Check to be sure the pattern matches to the pocket lining and change the placement of pocket lining if necessary). After Row 112 (124), SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back then knit to Row 151 (163). SHAPE NECK: Bind off 3 sts. lx, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. lx for both sizes and after Row 186 (198) SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.

POCKET BAND:

Cast on 22 sts. with color 2 and work 12 rows Stockinette stitch. Bind off. Fold the band in half with purl side out and sew to top of pocket.

FRONT AND NECK BAND:

Cast on 12 sts. with color 2 and work Stockinette stitch for approximately 80/90 cm (224/252) Rows.

BACK: II

Cast on 90 (100) sts. with color 2 and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. Continue in Pattern with color 1.

Knit to Row 112 (124).



Cast on 45 (50) sts. with color 2 and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. Continue in Pattern with color 1. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 18th row 6x for both sizes. After Row 134 (140) SHAPE CAP: Please follow the bind-offs on each side for the Cap Shaping in your size. After Row 174 (186), bind off the remaining sts.

A Tuck stitch Pattern. Punch your own Card and push in both Tuck Buttons. Waist Band is K1, P1 Ribbing. Crochet around front and sleeve edges.





After Row 90 (102) [108], SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x) [Same as 2nd size]. After Row 146 (158) [170], bind off the center 26 (26) [31] sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.
FOR SHOULDER, bind off 4 sts. 5x, 2 sts. 1x. (4 sts. 5x, 5 sts. 1x). [4 sts. 5x, 5 sts. 1x]. FOR NECK, bind off 2 sts. 2x for all sizes. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side in Pattern, turn the Row Counter back to 146 (158) [170] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *



PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

TRIM FOR DK 1001

If you want to make a knitted trim on the machine in place of a crochet edging - try this...

TENSION: 5

Cast on over 5 needles.

Knit 2 rows.

Set machine for holding needles.
*Put the 2 end needles on the LEFT into holding position and knit 10 rows over 3 needles.


Push the 4th needle into working position Knit 2 rows.

Push the end needle into working position

Knit 2 rows.

REPEAT FROM * for as long as you need.

Here is a new card for you to punch for use with your COLOR CHANGER. Use Fair Isle (Norwegian) technique and begin with *8 rows using 2 colors then 2 rows using 1 color then REPEAT from *. After you have made a sample, be creative and change the colors to make up your own design. The design can be used for Chair Covers, Place Mats, Cushions and other household items as well as for garments.
