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
editorial

All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

-  Increase
 -  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.
 -  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
 -  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.
 -  Pattern Stitch
 -  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Knit side.
 -  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Purl side.
 -  Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.
REPEAT the above for each complete row.
 -  Repeat
- I = Front
 - II = Back
 - III = Sleeve
 - IV = Skirt Front
 - V = Skirt Back
 - VI = Collar
 - VII = Pocket
 - VIII = Band
 - IX = Belt

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5×1
6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5×1 above the box means - 1 st. $5 \times \dots$ so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row $5 \times$.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...
 $3 \text{ sts. } 1 \times (2 \times) [3 \times], 2 \text{ sts. } 1 \times (2 \times) [3 \times], 1 \text{ st. } 3 \times (4 \times) [5 \times]$.
As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITTING machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS:

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box (or Slide) are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the Trip Control Lever so that only 1 row registers.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITTING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part.

Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn - Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will shown in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

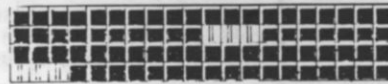

SIZES: 38 (40) [42]
YARN: Euro Sport

The front section has a small Pattern made by changing the 3 Purl sts. (as they face you) into knit sts. for 4 rows as shown on the Line Drawing (see picture). The knit side is the right side. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing with color stripes. SEE PRINTED COPY

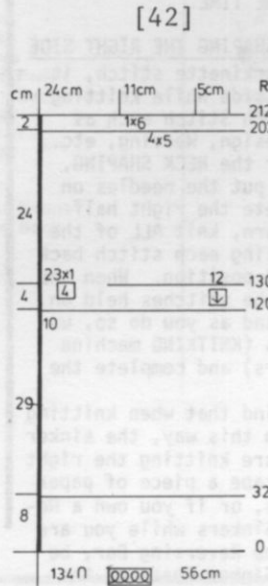
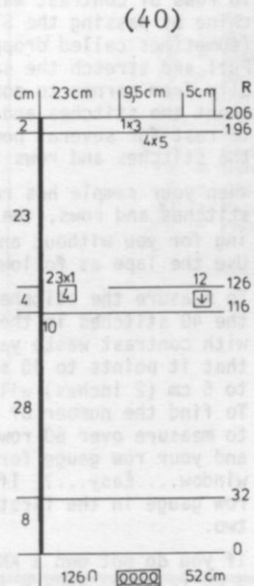
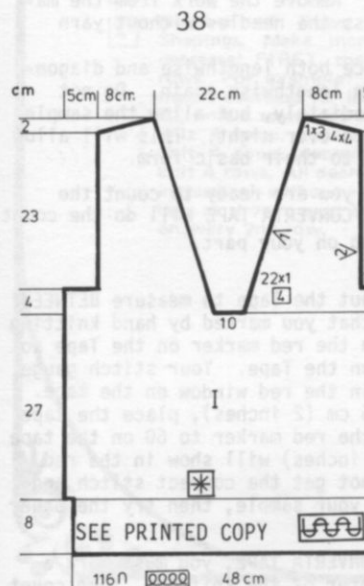
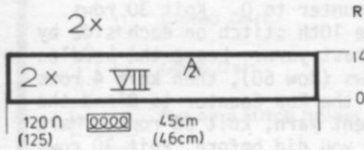

Cast on 116 (126) [134] sts. with color 2 and work 32 rows K1, P1 Ribbing with REPEATED color stripes of 2 rows color 2, 8 rows color 1.

Change to Stockinette stitch and continue with color 1. Knit to Row 124 (126) [130]. Bind off 12 sts. before knitting the next 2 rows, then knit to Row 194 (196) [202].

Bind off the center 14 (16) [18] sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

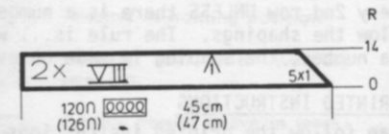
*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off 4 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 1x.

(5 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 1x). [5 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x].

FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 4x.

Bring the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 194 (196) [202] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



NECKBAND: VIII Make 2.

Cast on 120 (126) [126] sts. with color 2 and work K1, P1 Ribbing with REPEATED color stripes of 2 rows color 2, 4 rows color 1 and AT THE SAME TIME, on the RIGHT (left for 2nd section), on every 2nd row, decrease 1 st. 5x.

After Row 14, remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

FRONT: I

Cast on 116 (126) [134] sts. color 2. Work 32 rows K1, P1 Ribbing with REPEATED color stripes the same as the back.

Continue in Stockinette stitch with Pattern as shown on the Line Drawing. Knit to Row 114 (116) [120].

Bind off the center 10 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 22x (23x) [23x] and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 124 (126) [130], bind off 12 sts. for Armhole.

After Row 194 (196) [202], SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off

4 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 1x.

(5 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 1x). [5 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x].

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 114 (116) [120] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

MAN'S JACKET

SIZES: 36 (38) [40]
 YARN: Binia
 GRAMS:
 color 1 450 500 550
 color 2 100 100 100
 TENSION: 8 to 10
 GAUGE: 13 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with ribbed bands and color stripes. The Purl side is the right side. You will need a Jacket type Zipper.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Sew in zipper.



BACK: II

OPEN CAST ON. With contrast waste yarn, cast on 124 (134) [146] sts. Knit 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1 and put the Row Counter at 60. Work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 164 (170) [176], continue with color 1 and

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off

3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x].

Knit to Row 228 (238) [248]. SHAPE SHOULDER, AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 232 (242) [252], SHAPE NECK:

FOR SHOULDER, bind off

4 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 5x.

(5 sts. 5x, 6 sts. 1x).

[6 sts. 5x, 3 sts. 1x].

FOR NECK, after Row 232 (242) [252], bind off the center 22 (18) [20]

sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off

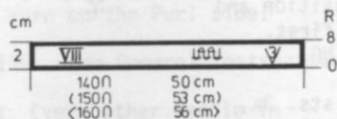
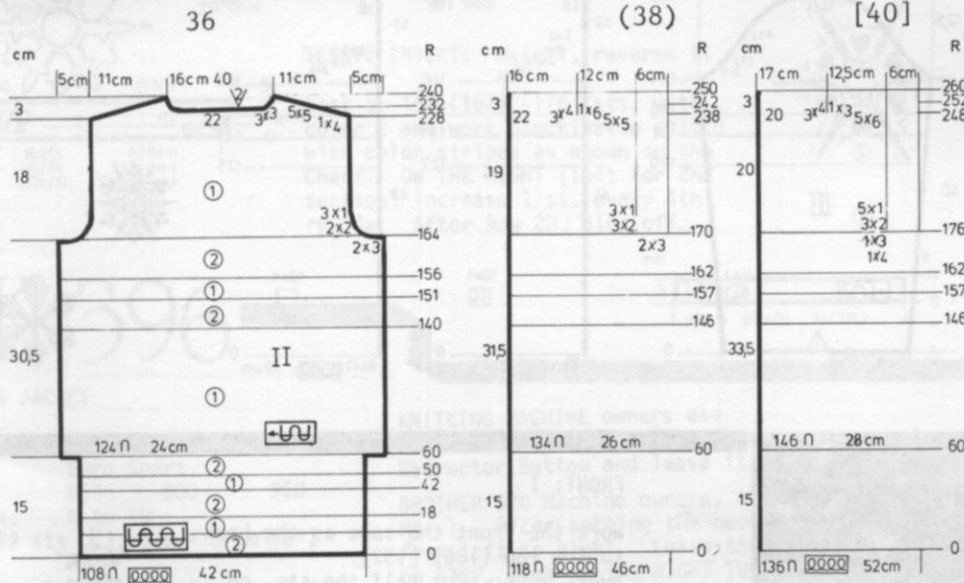
3 sts. 3x.

(4 sts. 3x).

[4 sts. 3x].

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 232 (242) [252] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * but don't forget to complete the shoulder shapings.

Hang the sts. held on waste yarn onto the machine, decreasing to 108 (118) [130] sts. Remove the waste yarn then hang every other stitch onto the Ribber, turn the Row Counter to 0 and work K1, P1 Ribbing with color stripes of 10 rows color 2, 8 rows color 1, 24 rows color 2, 8 rows color 1, 10 rows color 2. After Row 60, bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



FRONT BANDS: VIII Make.2

Cast on 140 (150) [160] sts. with color 1 and work 8 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

OPEN CAST ON. With waste yarn, cast on 60 (66) [72] sts. Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to color 1 and put Counter at 60.

Work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 164 (170) [176], continue with color 1.

After Row 165 (171) [177], SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off

4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x, then every 10th row 1 st. 3x.

(4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x, then every 10th row 1 st. 1x.).

[4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x, then every 10th row 1 st. 2x].

Knit to Row 214 (222) [228].

SHAPE NECK: Bind off

3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x; 1 st. 4x).

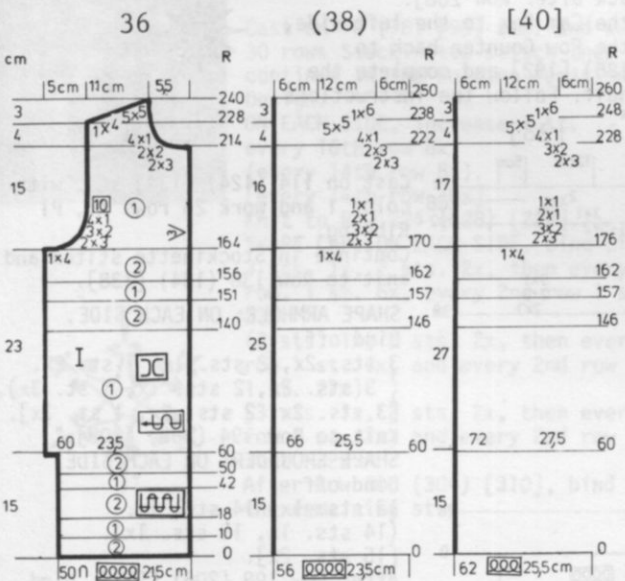
[3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 4x].

After Row 229 (239) [249], SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off

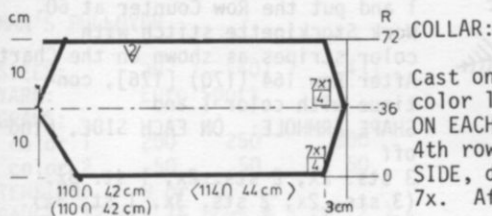

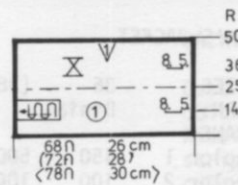

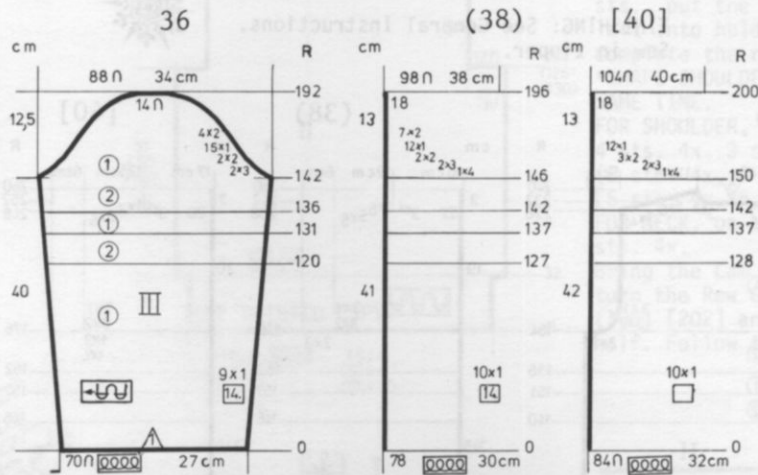

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 70 (78) [84] sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 9x (10x) [10x]. After Row 120 (126) [126], work the color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 142 (146) [150], continue with color 1 and SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 15x, 2 sts. 4x. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 12x, 2 sts. 7x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 12x, 2 sts. 7x]. After Row 192 (196) [200], bind off the remaining sts.

SIZES: 32 (36) [38]
YARN: Binia
GRAMS:
 color 1 350 (400) [450]

TENSION: 8 to 10
GAUGE: 13 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")



Stockinette stitch worn on the Purl side. The Sleeves are knitted sideways in 3 sections. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Sew the striped band of sleeve to each side of the inside edge of Sleeve sections.

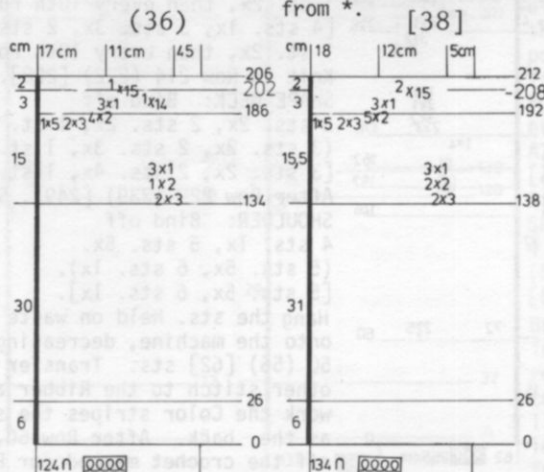
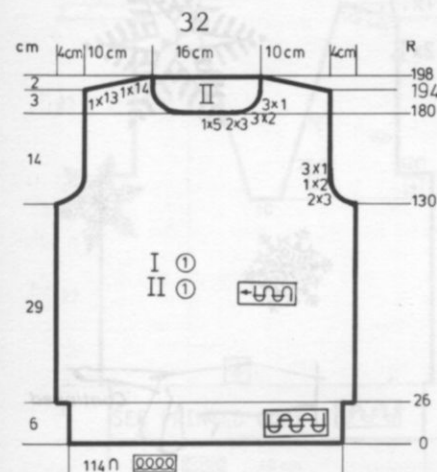

Work the front the same as the back to Row 180 (186) [192].
SHAPE NECK: Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. WATCH FOR SHOULDER SHAPING.
 *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 194. (5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 3x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 202). [5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 5x, 1 st. 3x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 208]. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 180 (186) [192] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



BACK: II

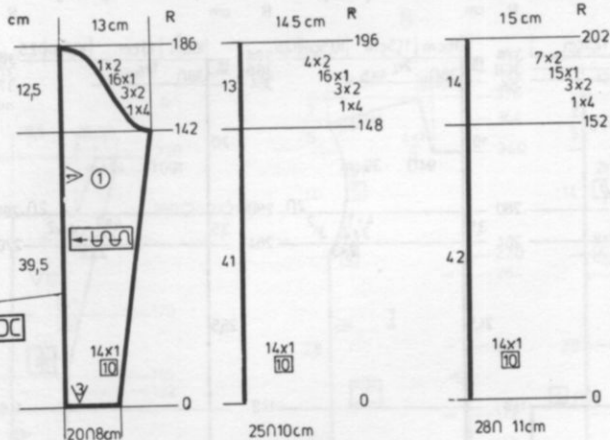
Cast on 114 (124) [134] sts. with color 1 and work 26 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch and knit to Row 130 (134) [138].
SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 2x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 3x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x]. Knit to Row 194 (202) [208].
SHAPE SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 13 sts. 1x, 14 sts. 1x. (14 sts. 1x, 15 sts. 1x). [15 sts. 2x]. After Row 198 (206) [212], bind off the remaining sts.

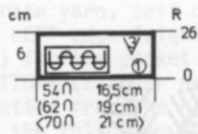

After Row 186 (196) [202], bind off the remaining sts.



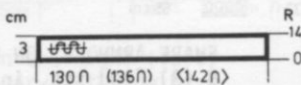

 off the crochet method for Ribbing.



FRONT & BACK: Make 1 reverse
 1.

Directly to the LEFT of 18 center
 needles, cast on 67 (71) sts.
 ON THE RIGHT (left for 2nd section)
 increase 1 st. every 8th row 9x AND
 AT THE SAME TIME, on the LEFT (right)
 decrease 1 st. after Row 28, 56 (also
 84 for the 2nd size).

After Row 80 (86), put these stitches
 into holding position and break yarn.
 Leave 9 empty needles to the right
 (left) of the stitches in holding
 position, then cast on 63 (67)
 sts. on the right (left).

On the LEFT (right) increase 1 st.
 every 8th row 9x AND AT THE SAME
 TIME, on the RIGHT (left), decrease
 1 st. after Rows 18, 36, 54, 72.

After Row 80 (86), bring the needles
 in holding position back into work-
 ing position and continue over all
 the needles.

Continue to SHAPE EACH SIDE at
 the same time.

On the LEFT (right) decrease 1 st.
 after Rows 84, 112 and on the RIGHT,
 (left), decrease 1 st. after Rows 90,
 108. 138 (146) sts.

After Row 114 (120) on the RIGHT (left)
 increase 1 st. every 10th row 6x and
 AT THE SAME TIME on the LEFT (right)
 increase 1 st. every 10th row 4x.
 Knit to Row 210 (220).

PLEASE FOLLOW THE CHART in your size
 for the DIFFERENT shapings on each
 side, taking off 15 sts. for the front
 crotch shaping and 19 sts. for the
 back crotch shaping. 114 (122) sts.
 remain.

Knit to Row 291 (305) then work
 SHORT ROWS:

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put
 into holding position
 10 (11) sts. 6x.

Bring all the needles back into working
 position and knit to Row 304 (318).

Bind off all sts.
 Work the second section with REVERSE
 shaping, casting on from right to
 left. Cam Box will be on the LEFT
 side at Row 0.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

PUNCH CARD ILLUSTRATIONS

You will note that in this issue of KNITKING MAGAZINE, we are providing PUNCH CARD ILLUSTRATIONS for some of the designs to be knitted into the garments.

If you have a KNITKING AM 3 machine, you can punch a blank JAC 40 Card. If you own a BROTHER 820 or a new KNITKING 830 machine, the Punch Card Illustrations are shown just as they should be punched. You can also punch the cards for a Studio machine, a Juki or any other machine that uses 24 stitch repeat punch cards. The color sequence, numbers of rows and color changes are printed along-side or below the card illustrations. You can if you like, mark your card accordingly or simply follow the printed instructions.

SEWING GARMENTS ON BABY LOCK OR SEWING MACHINE

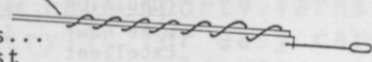
More and more knitters are putting their garments together by sewing them on a sewing machine. If you own a BABY LOCK 605, you can sew sections together using the chain stitch only, without cutting, or you can shape flat sections by using the cut, sew, overlock method. If you own a BABY LOCK 405, you use the cut, overlock method as this machine has a closed overlock and does not have the chain stitch. It is possible to sew knitted sections together on a regular sewing machine but you must be sure the tensions are set so that there is no pulling or ruffling on the knitting. You do not get a seam as elastic as with the BABY LOCK.

PIANO WIRES

Indispensable... inexpensive... and fantastic to use... are the sets of Piano Wires (3 long, 3 short in package - the price is \$1.95, Calif residents add Sales Tax, plus 50¢ shipping). You can throw away your blocking pins and forget basting threads when you use the Piano Wires...

FOR BLOCKING: Fold the back section of your knit in half with the right side to the inside. Using one of the wires (a long one for long edges, short for small edges).. catch the side edges of the knitting in an overcast stitch (see illustration).

Use another wire and go around the armholes... another one to overcast the neckline and shoulders... Do not stretch the knitting, but keep it smooth and flat and be sure to UNROLL the edges as you baste with the wire, catching only the very edge stitches with the wire. Now you are ready to steam or press the section. Be sure to use our new Pressing Cloths for perfect results. DO NOT PRESS the center back fold of course. - you can press this flat after you remove the wires. For the front sections... put the two fronts together with right sides inside and work the wires around the edges in the same way. Put the two sleeve sections together with right sides inside and do the same thing. You will find that this is the easiest way to block and have perfect edges for sewing together whether you weave the seams by hand or sew them on a machine. When the pressed sections are cool and dry, you can remove the wires.



FOR SEWING: Instead of pinning or basting with a thread, use the Piano Wires to hold the side seams together. If you are going to weave the seams from the right side, overcast with the wire on the right side of your knit (wrong side inside) If you are going to sew the seams on a sewing machine, the right sides should be inside. The wires will prevent stretching and hold the knitted pieces flat. You can sew along-side the wires being careful to keep them away from the presser foot and needle... or do as the experts do, pull the wire out as you sew. At first it may seem awkward, but you soon get the feel and the wire slips out just in front of the presser foot or front plate of the BABY LOCK. Practice on a bit of knitting first.

SOCKS for EVERYBODY

MATERIAL: KNITTING Fortissima (amounts as shown at right for each size). The amount of yarn specified is for slack length and you should order extra yarn for longer socks. The amount of yarn specified for Baby socks will make at least two pair. **TENSION:** 4 to 6. **GAUGE:** 18 sts., 24 rows to 2".

FINISHING: Weave the open heel sts. to open leg sts. Remove waste yarn. Weave back of leg seam and sides of instep. You may make these socks shorter or longer by knitting more or less rows for leg length. Increase the number of sts. for larger leg by casting on any number of sts. divisible by 4 plus 1 st. If knitting them very long, be sure to cast on sufficient sts. and space decreases along the leg edges for proper shaping so that you end up with a number of stitches divisible by 4 at the beginning of the instep. If you wish to seam the sock along the instep as you knit the sole, pick up edge stitches on each side of instep on every other row as you knit (see Practical Knitting Hints Book, page 24). You may also use a stripe pattern, cable design or a Norwegian pattern for the leg and instep sections.
