Knitting – Chart Symbols

- () Size Symbols (2nd Size)

- ① Color Number
-  Cast on
-  Stitch

All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.





-  Increase
-  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
-  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.









-  Pattern Stitch.

Finishing – Chart Symbols

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1

6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.

Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.

Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping'). Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the Tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the Tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window. If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

WOMAN'S TANK TOP & JACKET

SIZES: 7/8 (10/12) [14/16]

YARN: Euro Sport

GRAMS:
color 1 (Top) 150 150 200
color 2 (Jacket) 400 400 450

TENSION: 8 for Top
10 for Jacket

GAUGE: Top: 12 sts. 16 rows = 5 cm (2")
Jacket: 11 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")

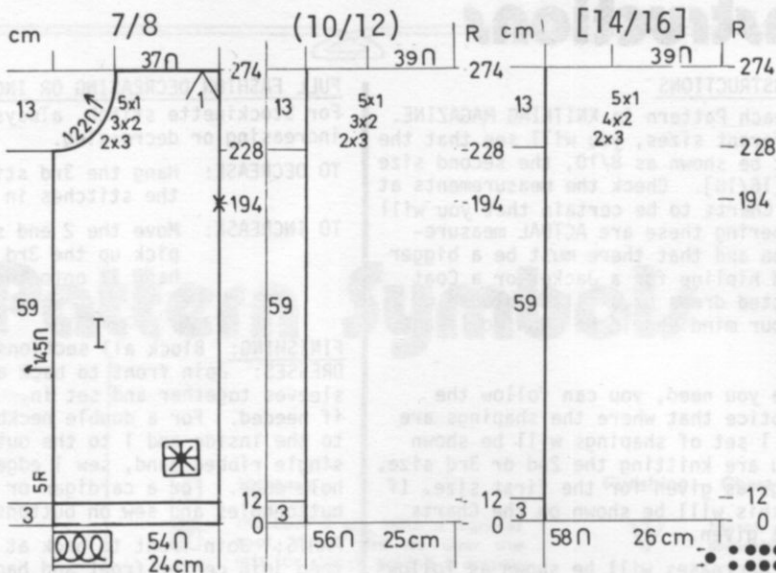
The Top is a Rib Pattern as given in the Instructions with bands K1, P1 Ribbing. The Jacket is an Eyelet Design. Punch your own Card or KNITTING machine owners use Card No. 419 in Volume 6 set of Punchcards. BE SURE TO PAY ATTENTION TO THE DIRECTIONS OF ARROWS on the Punchcard as you will move the Lace Carriage until the arrows show the directions of the Knit Carriage.

The Bands for Jacket are in Garter Stitch using hand knitting needles.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.

JACKET BANDS:

BACK: Pick up 116 sts. with hand knitting needles (3 1/2 mm) and work 10 rows Garter Stitch (5 ridges on the right side) Bind off. For Lower Front Bands, pick up 145 sts. For Front Bands, pick up 122 sts. and for Armhole Bands, pick up 102 sts. Work all bands the same as the back.



JACKET FRONT: Make 1, reverse

Cast on 54 (56) [58] sts. Set Counter at 12 and continue in Eyelet Design.

Mark Row 194 for armhole, then knit to Row 227.

SHAPE NECK: Bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x (same as first size).

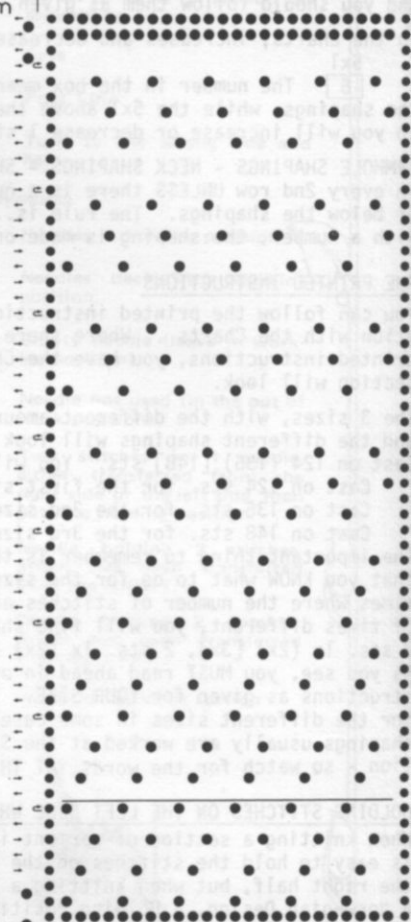
[3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 5x After Row 274, bind off the remaining sts.



TANK TOP: Make 2 sections the same.

Cast on 106 (110) [116] sts. with color 1 and work 24 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.

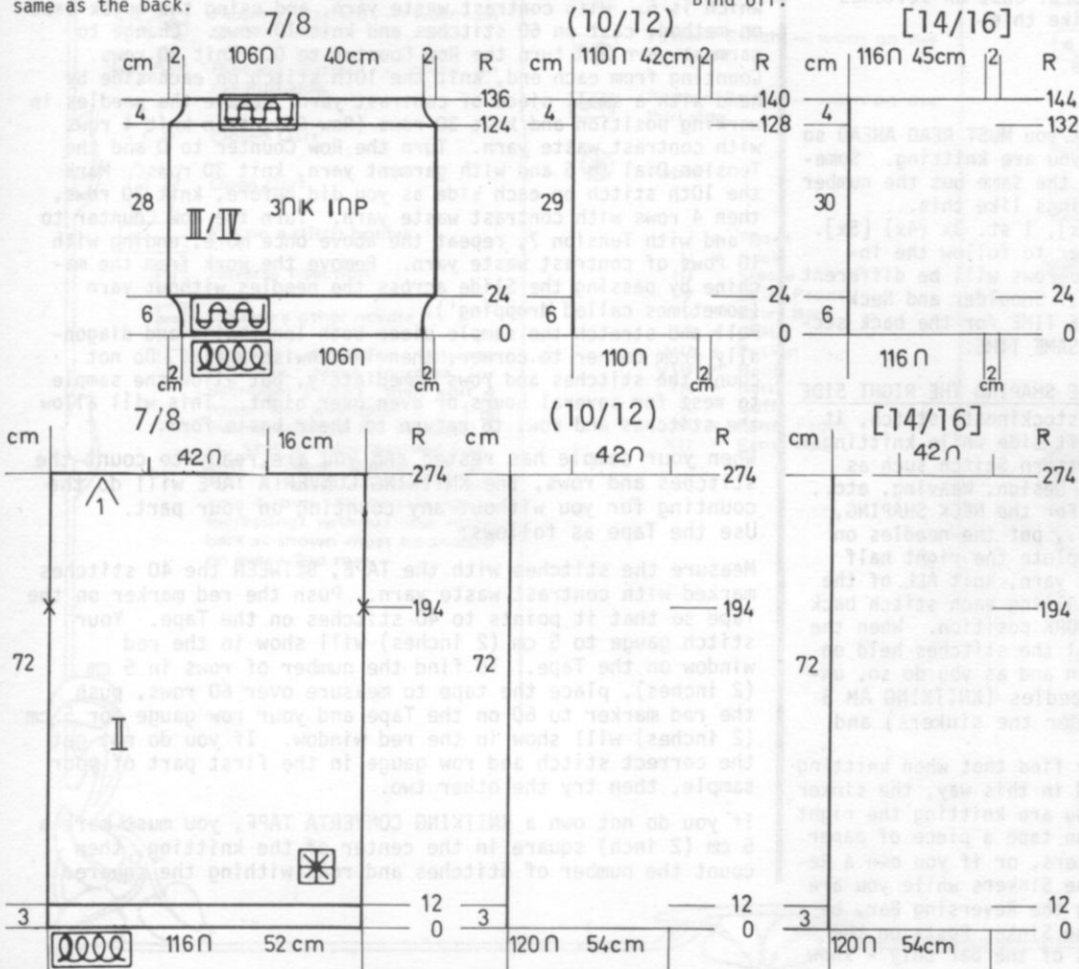
Set into Pattern of 3 knit, 1 purl and continue to Row 124 (128) [132]. Return Pattern to K1, P1 Ribbing and knit to Row 136 (140) [144]. Bind off.



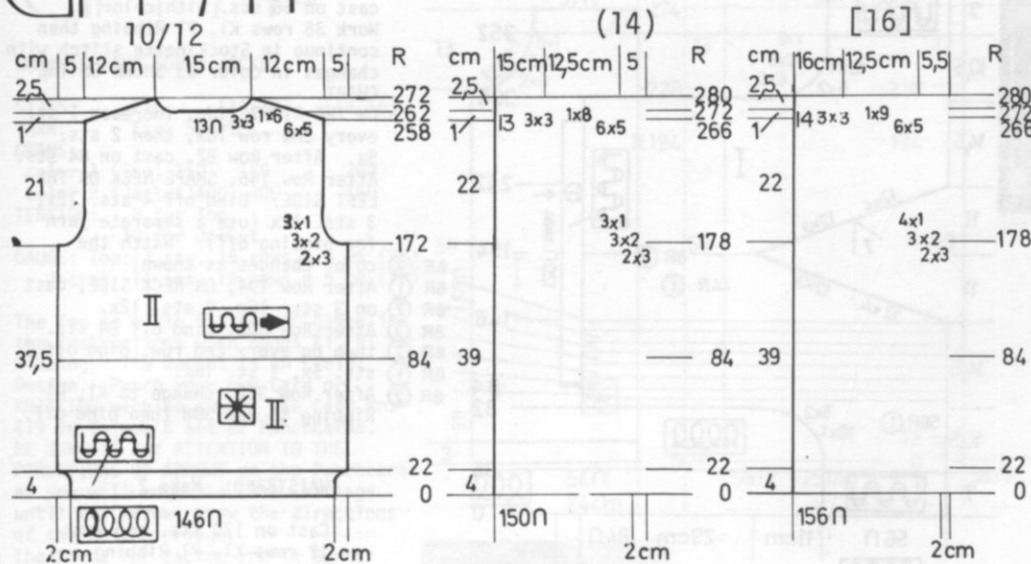
FOR ALTERNATE BANDS - You can pick up the stitches and work Stockinett stitch for a doubled hem - or any pattern stitch of your choice, but be sure to make a sample swatch first and make certain that the bands are smooth and flat.

JACKET BACK:

Cast on 116 (120) [120] sts. with waste yarn and knit 8 to 10 rows. Change to color 2 and work the Eyelet Design (Put Counter at 12). After Row 194, mark each side with a bit of waste yarn for armhole. Knit to Row 274. Remove the 42 neck sts. onto waste yarn and bind off shoulder sts. on each side.

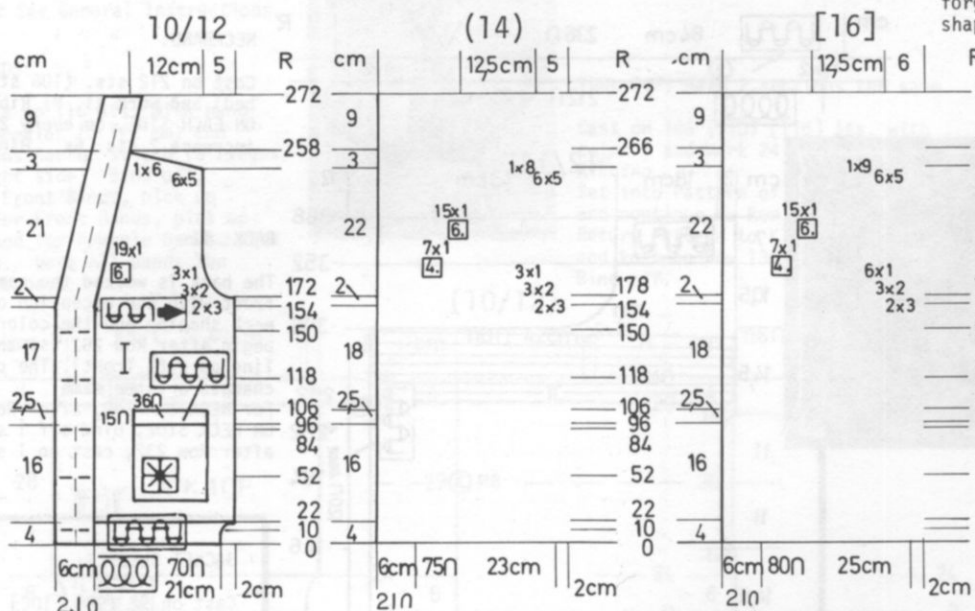


JACKET BACK:

Cast on 146 (150) [156] sts. and work 22 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Eyelet Pattern to Row 84, then continue in Stockinette stitch.

After Row 172 (178) [178], SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x]. After Row 258 (266) [266], SHAPE SHOULDER (and WATCH FOR NECK SHAPING). FOR SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 6x, 6 sts. 1x, (5 sts. 6x, 8 sts. 1x), [5 sts. 6x, 9 sts. 1x], AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 262 (272) [272], put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 13 (13) [14] sts. then bind off 3 sts. 3x for all sizes. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 262 (272) [272] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.



RIGHT FRONT BAND: Cast on 21 sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 10 rows, Make BUTTONHOLES over needles 4 to 7 and 14 to 17 counting from the left edge. Knit 32 rows, and make BUTTONHOLES over same needles as before. REPEAT the BUTTONHOLES every 32 rows to Row 96. Remove these sts. onto waste yarn.

FOR FRONT - Cast on 70 (75) [80] sts. and work 22 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Eyelet Pattern to Row 84. Continue in Stockinette stitch. Put 15 sts. on the left (right for left front) into holding position and over the next 36 sts. work 8 rows K1, P1 Ribbing (or you can remove the pocket sts. and work the ribbing later if you prefer). Bind off the pocket sts.. Hang the pocket lining sts. back onto machine over the empty needles and continue in Stockinette stitch. After Row 96, hang the front band sts. back onto the machine and continue over all the needles. Make 2 more BUTTONHOLES as you did before, 32 rows apart.

After Row 154 SHAPE NECK ON THE LEFT, (right for 2nd section). Hang the 21st stitch onto the 22nd st. and move the sts. over to fill the empty needle. REPEAT the decrease every 6th row 18x more (every 4th row 7x, every 6th row 15x [same as 2nd size], but AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 172 (178) [178], SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x, (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x), [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x], and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 258 (266) [266]. Continue over the front band to Row 272. Remove the sts. onto waste yarn.

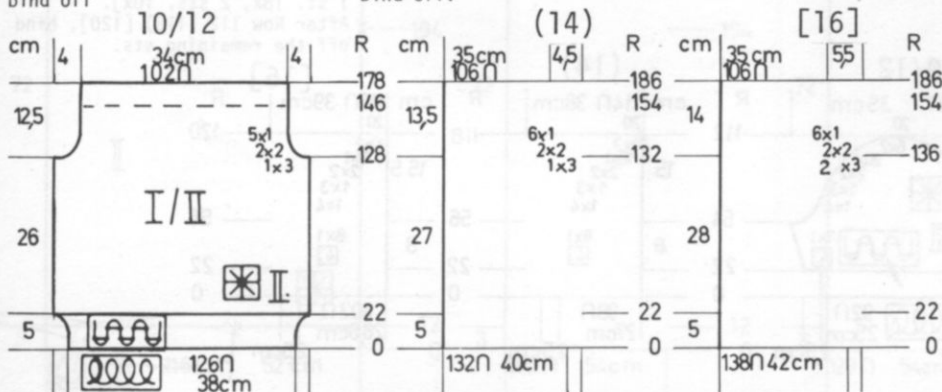
JACKET FRONT: Make 1, reverse 1 and omit buttonholes on left front band.

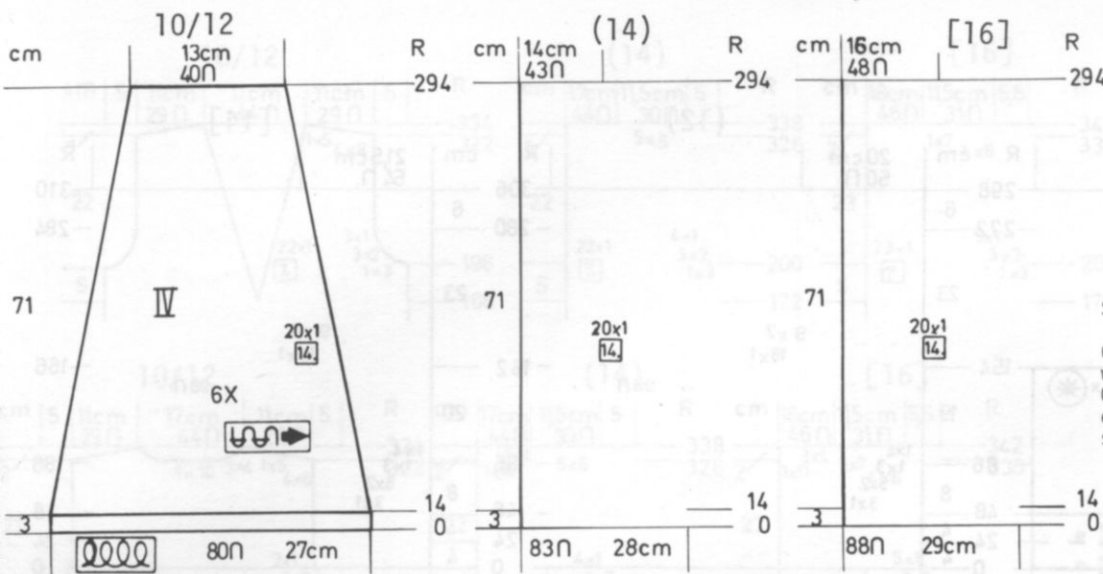
Work the pocket lining first, then part of the front band following the instructions. For pocket lining, cast on 36 sts. and work 40 rows Stockinette stitch. Remove onto waste yarn. Make a 2nd lining the same.

TOP: Make 2 sections the same.

Cast on 126 (132) [138] sts. and work 22 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Eyelet Pattern. Knit to Row 128 (132) [136]. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off

3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x]. Knit to Row 146 (154) [154] then continue in Stockinette stitch to Row 178 (186) [186]. Bind off.





SKIRT: IV Make 6 sections.
 Cast on 80 (83) [88] sts. and work Stockinette stitch.
 ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 14th row 20x for all sizes. After Row 294, bind off.

WOMAN'S JACKET & PULLOVER WITH STRAPS.

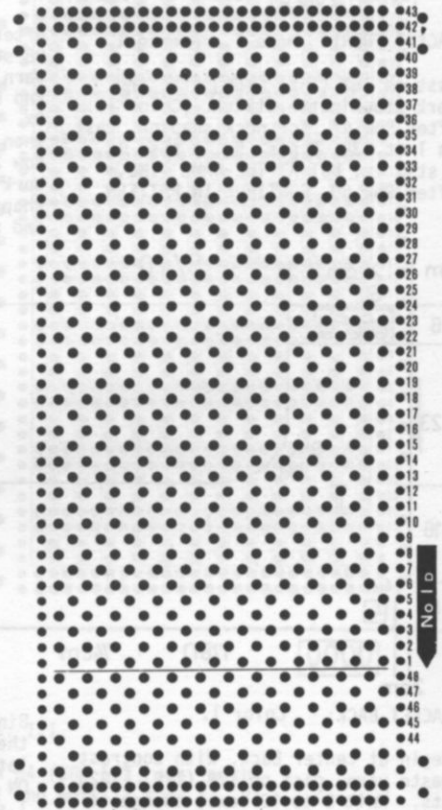
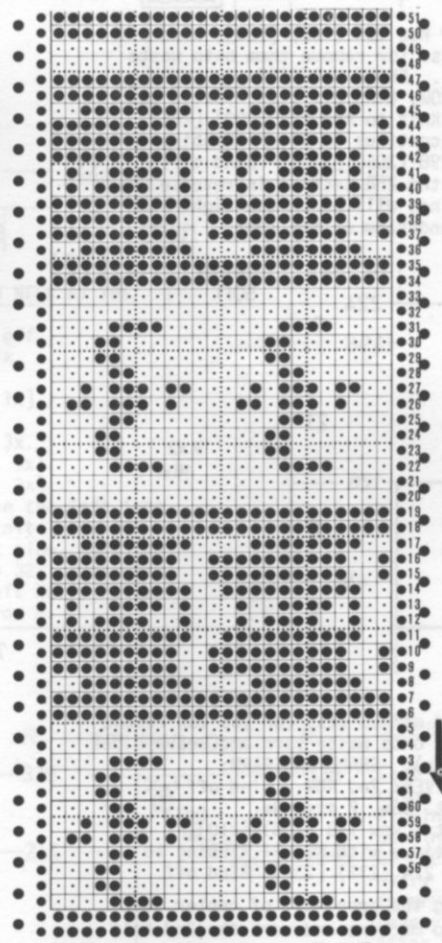
SIZES: 8/10 (12) [14]
 YARN: Amore
 GRAMS:
 color 1 550 550 600
 color 2 100 100 150
 color 3 50 50 100
 TENSION: 7 to 9
 GAUGE:
 Pull: 14 sts. 22 rows = 5 cm (2")
 Jacket: 12 sts. 24 rows = 5 cm (2")



The Pullover is a Norwegian Design. The Jacket is knitted sideways on the machine in a combination of Stockinette stitch, Tuck and an Eyelet Design. Sleeve bands of Jacket and bands of Pullover are Ribbed.

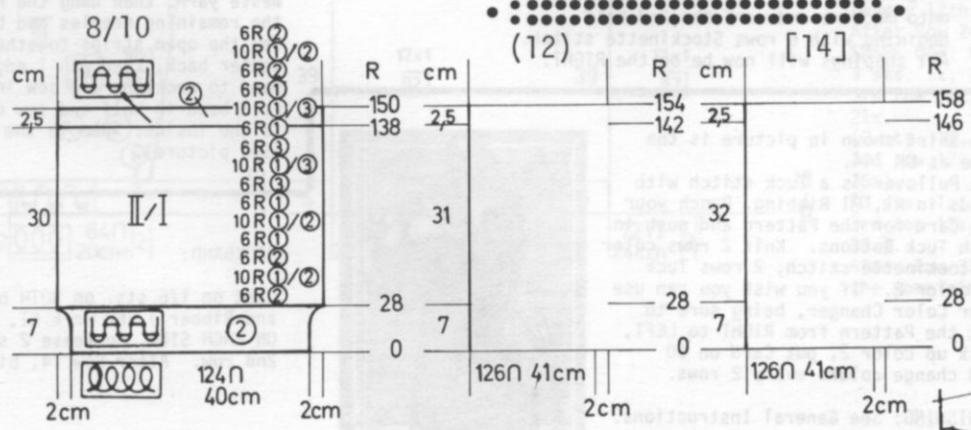
FINISHING: See General Instructions. Sew neckband strips together and place seam at center back of jacket. Sew 70 sts. on each side of center seam to neckline of jacket (see picture). Sew straps on Pullover.

PULLOVER STRAPS: Make 2.
 Cast on 19 sts. with color 2 and work K1, P1 Ribbing for 30 cm (12"). Bind off.



PULLOVER: Make 2 sections the same.

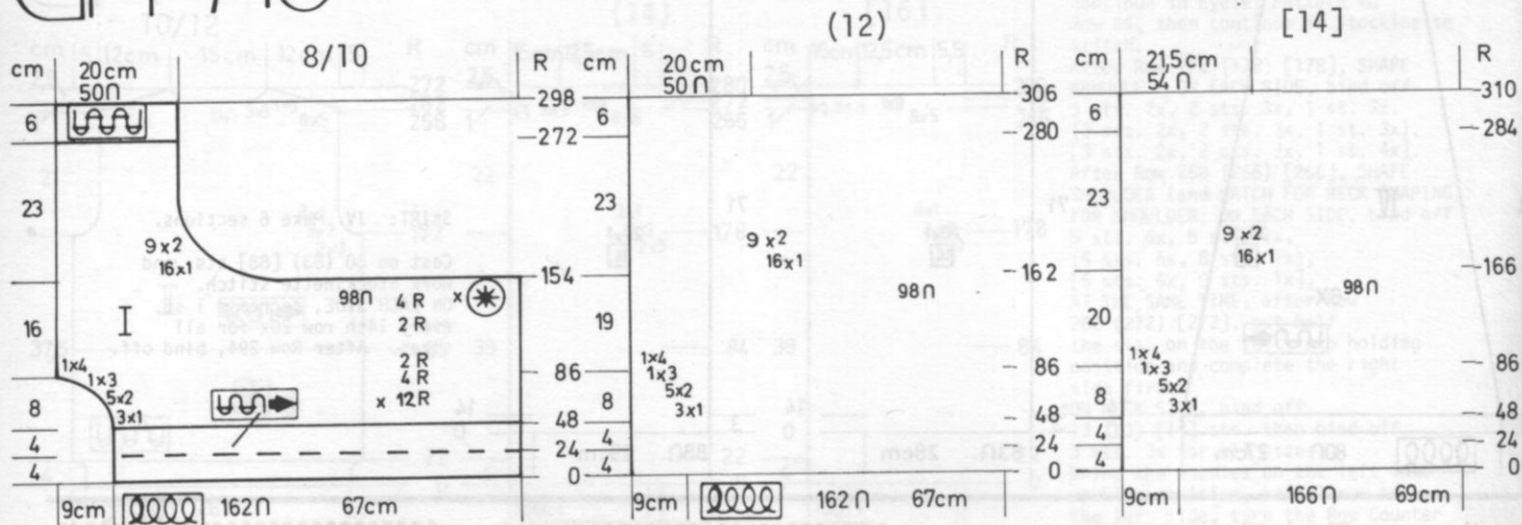
Cast on 124 (126) [126] sts. with color 2 and work 28 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in the Norwegian Design following the chart for the changes in color. After Row 138 (142) [146], continue in K1, P1 Ribbing with color 2 to Row 150 (154) [158]. Bind off.



JACKET PATTERN - 830 Machine owners use Card No. 1 of your original set. Leave on STOP throughout.
 *12 rows Stockinette stitch.
 4 rows Tuck.
 2 rows Stockinette stitch.
 1 row Eyelets.
 2 rows Stockinette stitch.
 4 rows Tuck.
 REPEAT FROM * for Pattern.



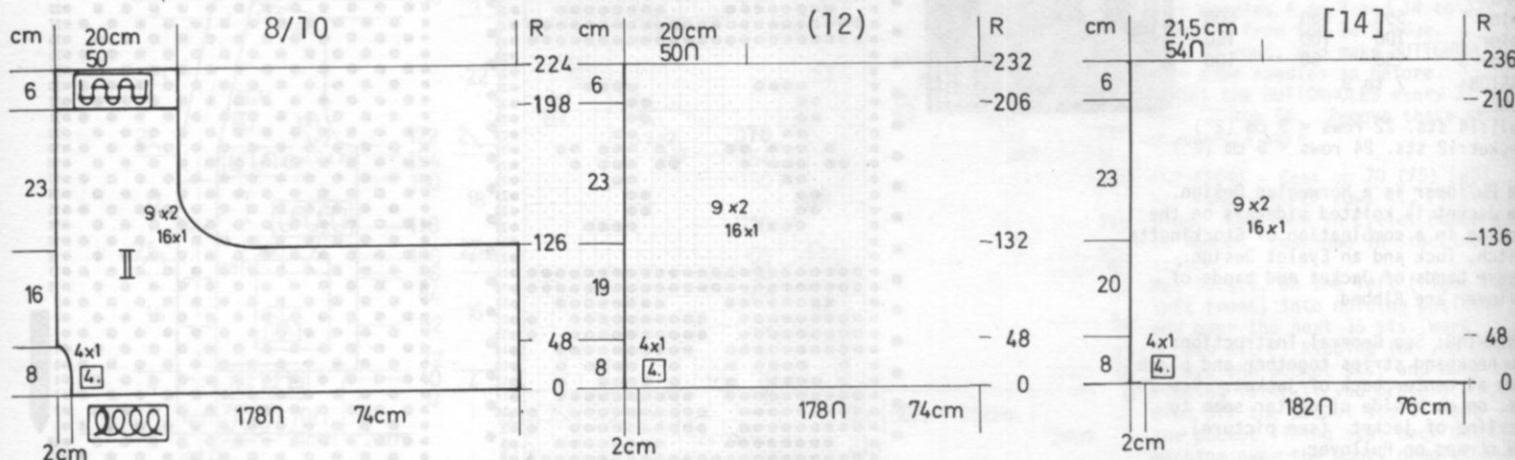

JACKET FRONT: Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 162 (162) [166] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. (Color 1). After Row 47, for neck shaping, cast on 1 st. 3x, 2 sts. 5x, 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, BUT AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 60, CONTINUE IN PATTERN.

After Row 154 (162) [166], bind off 98 sts. (or remove them onto waste yarn). SHAPE UNDERARM: ON EVERY 2nd ROW, bind off 1 st. 16x, 2 sts. 9x. Knit to Row 272 (280) [284], then continue in K1, P1 Ribbing to Row 298 (306) [310]. Bind off. Work the 2nd section in reverse. Neck shapings will be on the right side and underarm on the left.



JACKET BACK: Color 1.

Begin at center Back. With contrast waste yarn, cast on 178 (178) [182] sts. Knit 8 to 10 rows, change to garment yarn and put Counter at 0. Begin with 6 rows Stockinette stitch (instead of 12) then continue with Pattern. AT THE SAME TIME, on every 2nd row, cast on 1 st. 4x on the left side (right for 2nd half) for the neck shaping. Knit to Row 126 (132) [136].

Bind off 98 sts. (or you can remove them onto waste yarn and weave sides later). SHAPE UNDERARM: ON EVERY 2nd ROW, bind off 1 st. 16x, 2 sts. 9x. Knit to Row 198 (206) [210]. Continue with K1, P1 Ribbing to Row 224 (232) [236]. Bind off.

Hang the open sts. of center back onto machine and work the 2nd half beginning with 6 rows Stockinette stitch. All shapings will now be on the RIGHT.

JACKET NECK & FRONT BANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 200 sts. with waste yarn as you did for back. After knitting 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1 and put counter at 0. Knit 48 rows Stockinette stitch. Remove 70 sts. at one side onto waste yarn, then hang the hem over the remaining needles and bind off. Sew the open strips together at center back, then pin 1 edge of band to neckline and sew in place. Fold band in half and sew other edge to the inside. Remove the waste yarn. (See picture).

WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 10/12 (14) [16]
 YARN: Fortissima
 GRAMS:
 color 1 300 300 350
 color 2 200 200 250
 TENSION: 7 to 9
 GAUGE: 13 sts. 29 rows = 5 cm (2")

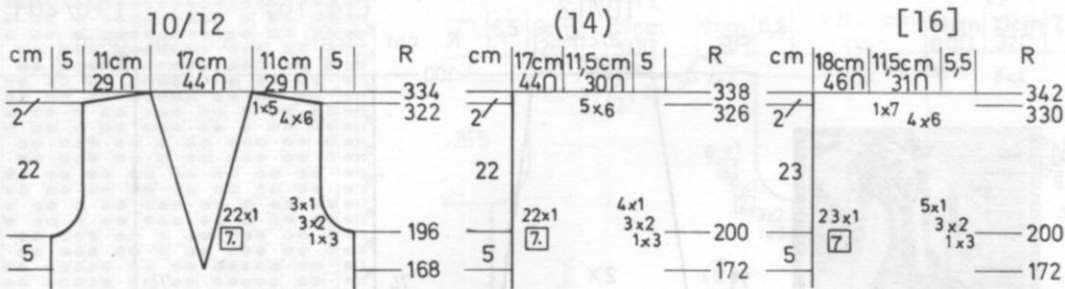
The Skirt shown in picture is the same as DK 744. The Pullover is a Tuck stitch with bands in K1, P1 Ribbing. Punch your own Card for the Pattern and push in both Tuck Buttons. Knit 2 rows color 1 Stockinette stitch, 2 rows Tuck in color 2. If you wish you can use your Color Changer, being sure to set the Pattern from RIGHT to LEFT, pick up color 2, put Card on GO and change colors every 2 rows.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



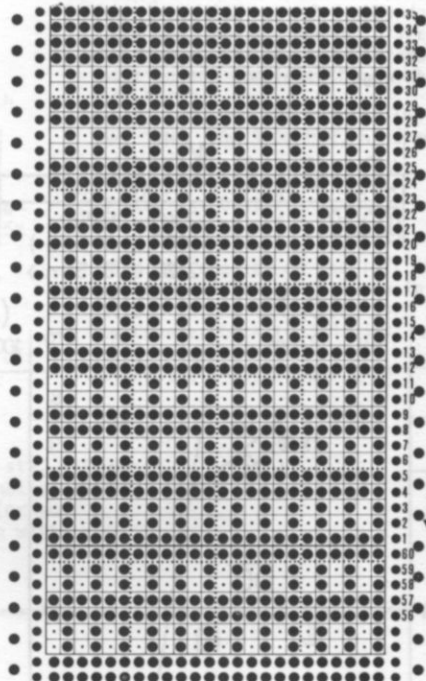
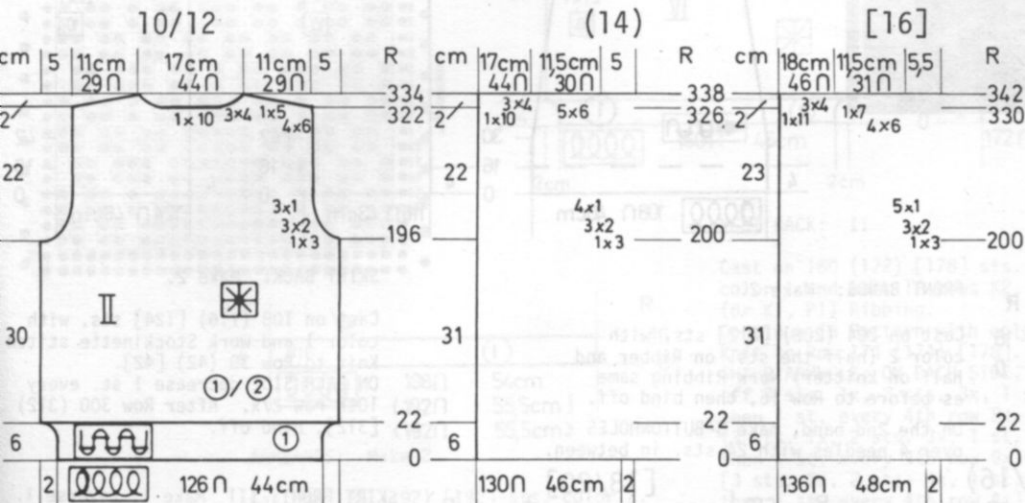
NECKBAND:

Cast on 176 sts. on BOTH beds (Knitter and Ribber) and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. every 2nd row. After Row 14, bind off.



FRONT: I

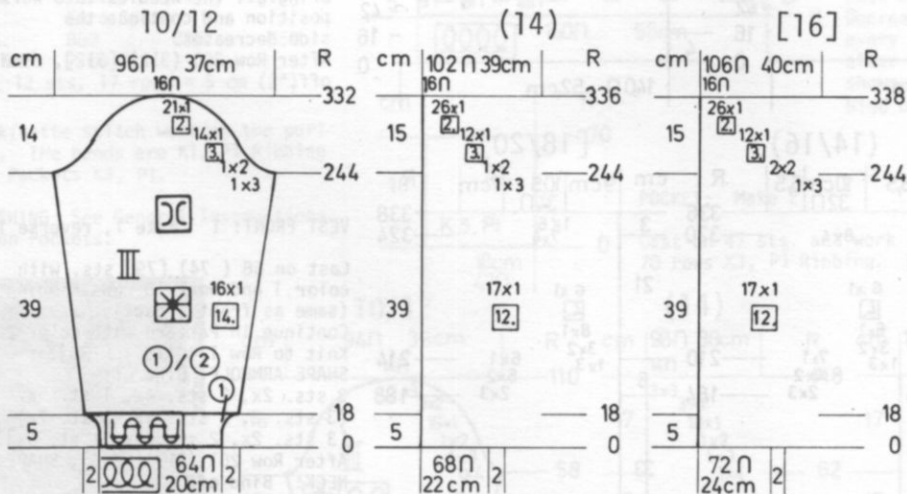
Work the front the same as the back to Row 168 (172) [172]. Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 7th row 22x (22x) [23x] BUT AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 196 (200) [200], SHAPE ARMHOLE SAME AS THE BACK, and after Row 322 (326) [330] SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 168 (172) [172] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



BACK: II

Cast on 126 (130) [136] sts. with color 1 and work 22 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Pattern. Knit to Row 196 (200) [200]. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x]. Knit to Row 322 (326) [330]. Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 6 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 1x, (6 sts. 5x), [6 sts. 4x, 7 sts. 1x], FOR NECK: Bind off 10 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 3x. (10 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 3x). [11 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 3x]. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 322 (326) [330] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



SLEEVES: III

Cast on 64 (68) [72] sts. with color 1 and work 18 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Pattern. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 16x. (every 12th row 17x). [every 12th row 17x]. After Row 244 (244) [244], SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. every 3rd row 14x, 1 st. every 2nd row 21x. Cast on 200 sts. and work 12 rows Ribbing but at the same time on every 2nd row, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. 6x. Bind off.

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 64 sts. and work 28 rows Ribbing. Continue in Pattern but increase 6 sts. evenly across first.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 12th row 14x. (every 11th row 16x). [every 9th row 19x].
After Row 212, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 9 sts. 4x for all sizes.
After Row 220, bind off the remaining sts.

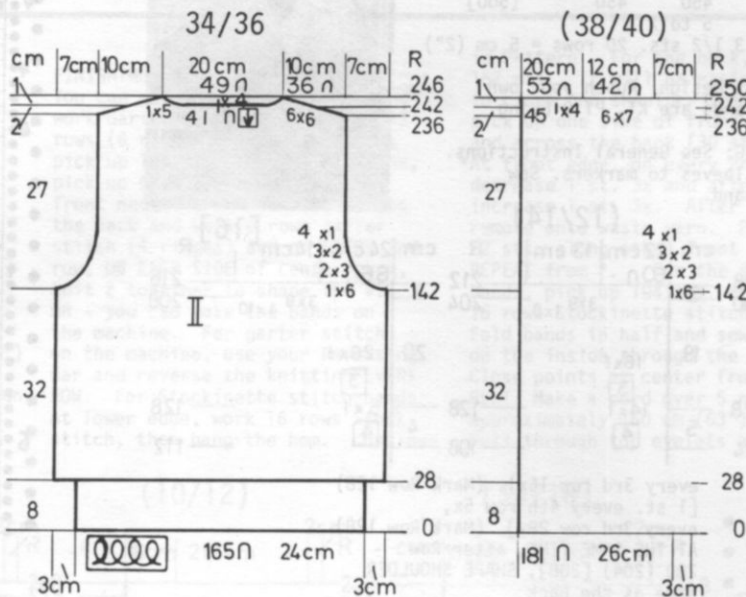

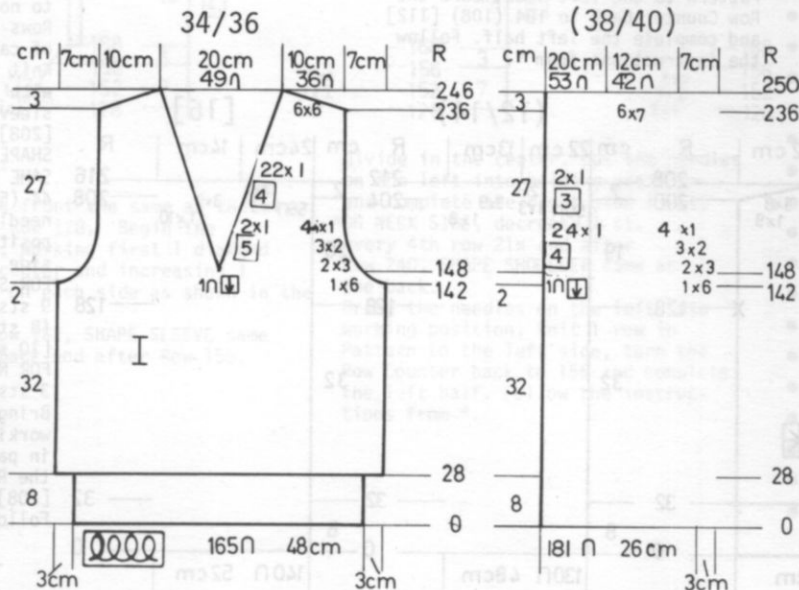

ON EACH SIDE, for SHOULDER, bind off 6 sts. 6x, (7 sts. 6x),
AT THE SAME TIME, *after Row 242, bind off the center 41 (45) sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 242 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.

FRONT: I

Cast on 165 (181) sts. and work 28 rows Ribbing.
Set up the needles with the 9 center needles on the main machine with the Rib and Eyelet Design on each side of the cable sts.
Continue in Pattern as shown on both Line Drawings.
Knit to Row 142
SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back but AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 148, transfer the center st. to its neighboring needle, put the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
*ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 5th row 2x, every 4th row 22x. (every 4th row 24x, every 3rd row 2x).
After Row 236, SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 148 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

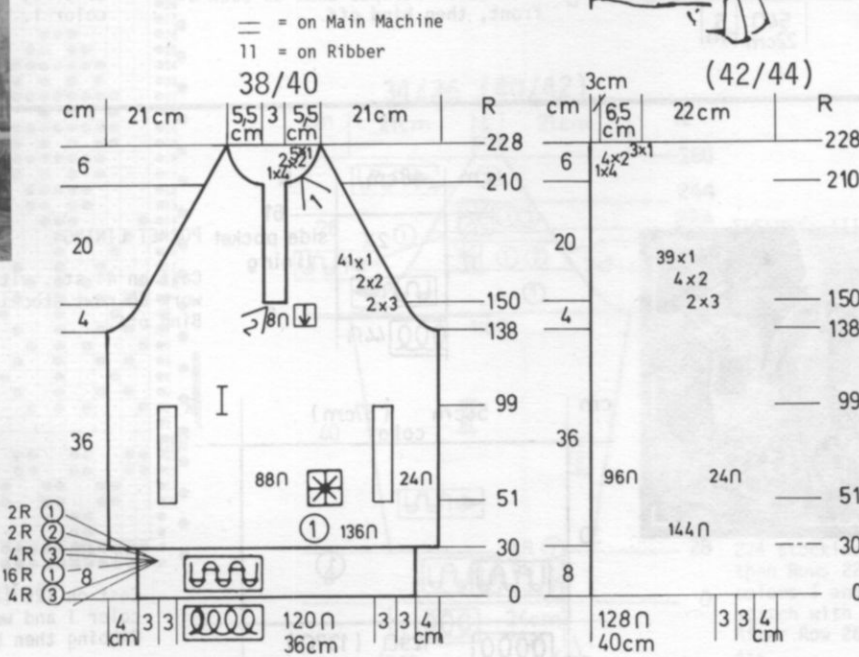

ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 41x, (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 39x), BUT AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 150, Bind off the center 8 sts. put the needles on left into holding position and complete the right side first. 138 *After Row 209, ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x. (4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 3x). Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 150 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * continuing the raglan shaping at the same time.

Hang the open sts. held on waste yarn back onto the machine, decreasing to 120 (128) sts. Work 30 rows Ribbing with color stripes same as back then bind off

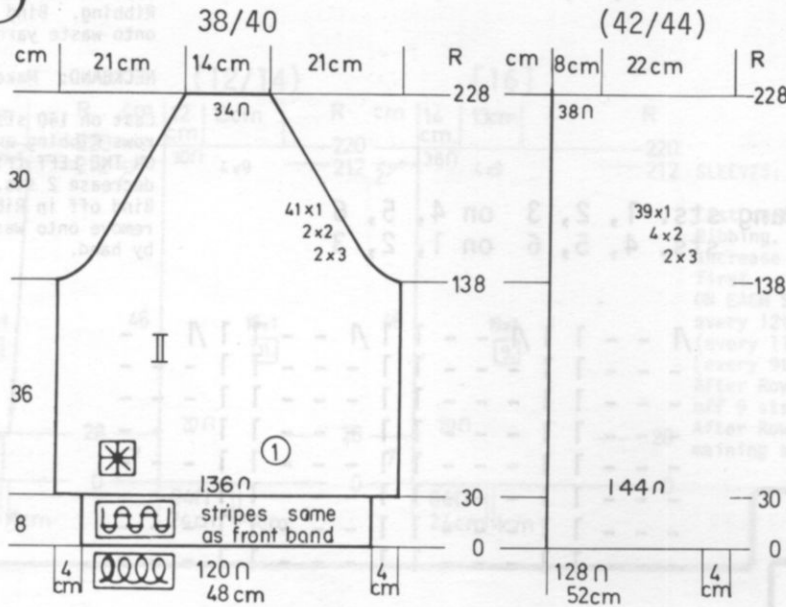

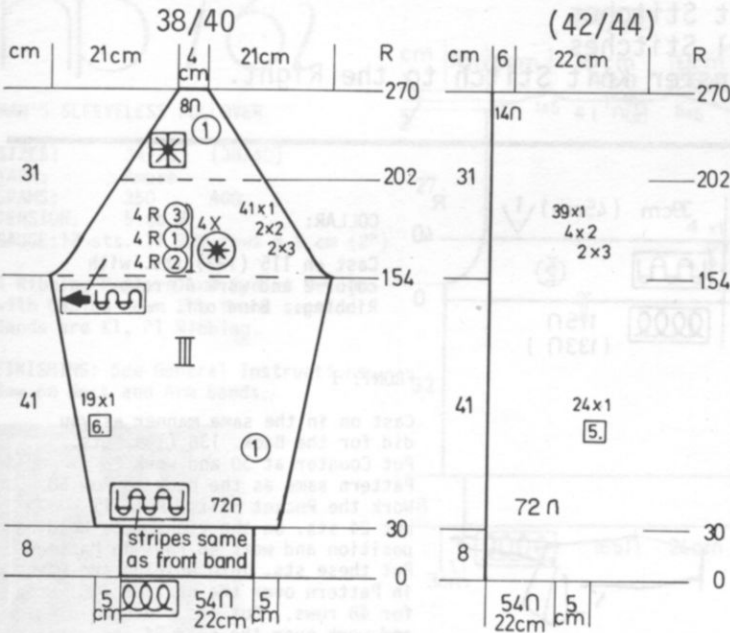

With waste yarn, cast on 136 (144) sts. After knitting 11 or 13 rows, knit 1 row with main yarn (color 1) the right. Transfer the sts. to the ribber as shown in the line drawing then put Counter at 30. Continue in Pattern. Knit to Row 138. SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, bind off, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, then decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 41x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, then decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 39x. After Row 228, bind off the remaining sts.

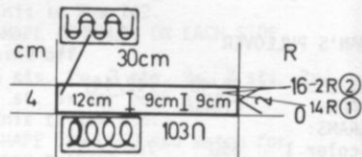
Hang the open sts. back onto the machine, decreasing to 120 (128) sts. Work 30 rows in Ribbing with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Bind off in Ribbing.



SLEEVES: III

Cast on in the same manner as you did for front and back. 72 sts. for both sizes. Put Counter at 30 and work in Pattern with color 1. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 19x. (every 5th row 24x). After Row 154, continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart and ON EACH SIDE, SHAPE RAGLAN: Bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 41x, (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x. 1 st. 39x), AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 202, Continue in Pattern to Row 270. Bind off the remaining sts.

Hang the sts. held on waste yarn back onto the machine, decreasing to 54 sts. Work 30 rows Ribbing with color stripes same as back & front, then bind off.



FRONT & COLLAR BAND: Make 2.

Cast on 103 sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing. 14 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2. Bind off See Practical Knitting Hints in this issue for Buttonholes

POCKET BANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 41 sts. with color 3 and work in Ribbing, 2 rows color 3, 4 rows color 2, 8 rows color 1. Bind off

After Row 266, bind off the remaining sts.



KNITTING NEWS

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

If you want a permanent cast-on edge (for instance for a pleated skirt), here is an easy way.

Bring the required number of needles into working position. Hang the cast on comb. Bring every other needle into "E" position (all the way forward). Push in LEFT PART BUTTON.

With contrast waste yarn, knit 1 row to the left. Drop the cast on comb and release part button. Knit at least 1" of waste knitting.

With garment yarn, cast on using the "e" method (permanent edge) right over the waste yarn, behind the latches of the needles (bring the needles into "E" position to make it easier to cast on). The cast on should be from left to right.

Turn the tension to 1 number lower than the one you will use for knitting your garment.

Knit 2 rows. If you are working a Pattern stitch, set the card after knitting the first row.

Turn Tension to garment tension, put Counter at 0 and continue with your garment.

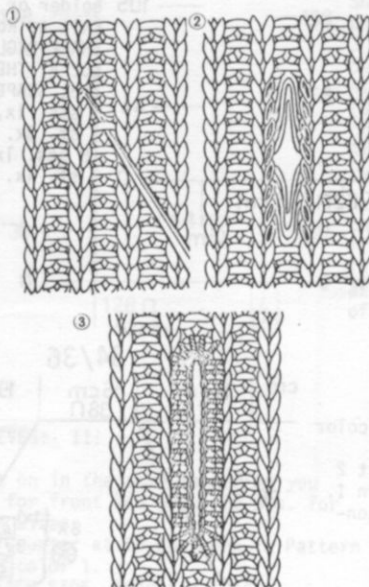
Block the section and use the waste knitting to push pins into and hold the pleats in place. After blocking is completed, cut the first row of the waste yarn and pull this row out. Now it is easy to unravel the waste yarn down to the permanent cast on edge.

TRANSPORT YOUR MACHINE WITH KNITTING ON IT...

Dani Carver of Duarte, Calif. teaches machine knitting at Adult Education Classes in Altadena. She gave us this handy hint. When it is impossible to complete a section of a garment at class, instead of removing the knitting onto waste yarn, Dani has her students purchase plastic spines sold at the 5 & 10 cent stores or stationery stores. At this date, we have found that they are not sold separately anymore and you must purchase a package of plastic paper holders which come with the color spines. There are 4 or 6 in a package and they cost approximately \$1.00. Use the spines to slip over the front posts (gate pegs) of your machine - leave the knitting on the machine ready for the next row. You will have to use enough of the spines to cover all the stitches (they are 11" long). You can now pick up the machine without worrying about your knitting. If you remember to carry some tissue paper with you, you can roll your knitting up in the tissue and place it on top of the needle bed.

NARROW BANDS OF RIBBING

When you must have a narrow band of Ribbing - say 6 or 8 rows, it is much easier to remove the sts. of the band when completed, onto waste yarn. When you have knitted the band, transfer the Ribber sts. to the main machine then remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn. Pick up the number of required sts. around a neckline, armhole or wherever you need the band (WRONG SIDE FACING YOU) then hang the open sts. of the band onto these same needles. Bind off the double sts. together.



RIBBING BUTTONHOLE

The open necked Pull-over, HP 763 has a Rib band with buttonholes. The illustration on the left shows a simple way to make a small buttonhole. With a crochet hook, spread and pull the knitting apart for as many rows needed for an opening. Tack the opening at each end then work a buttonhole stitch all around the opening. Use matching buttonhole twist or fine matching yarn.

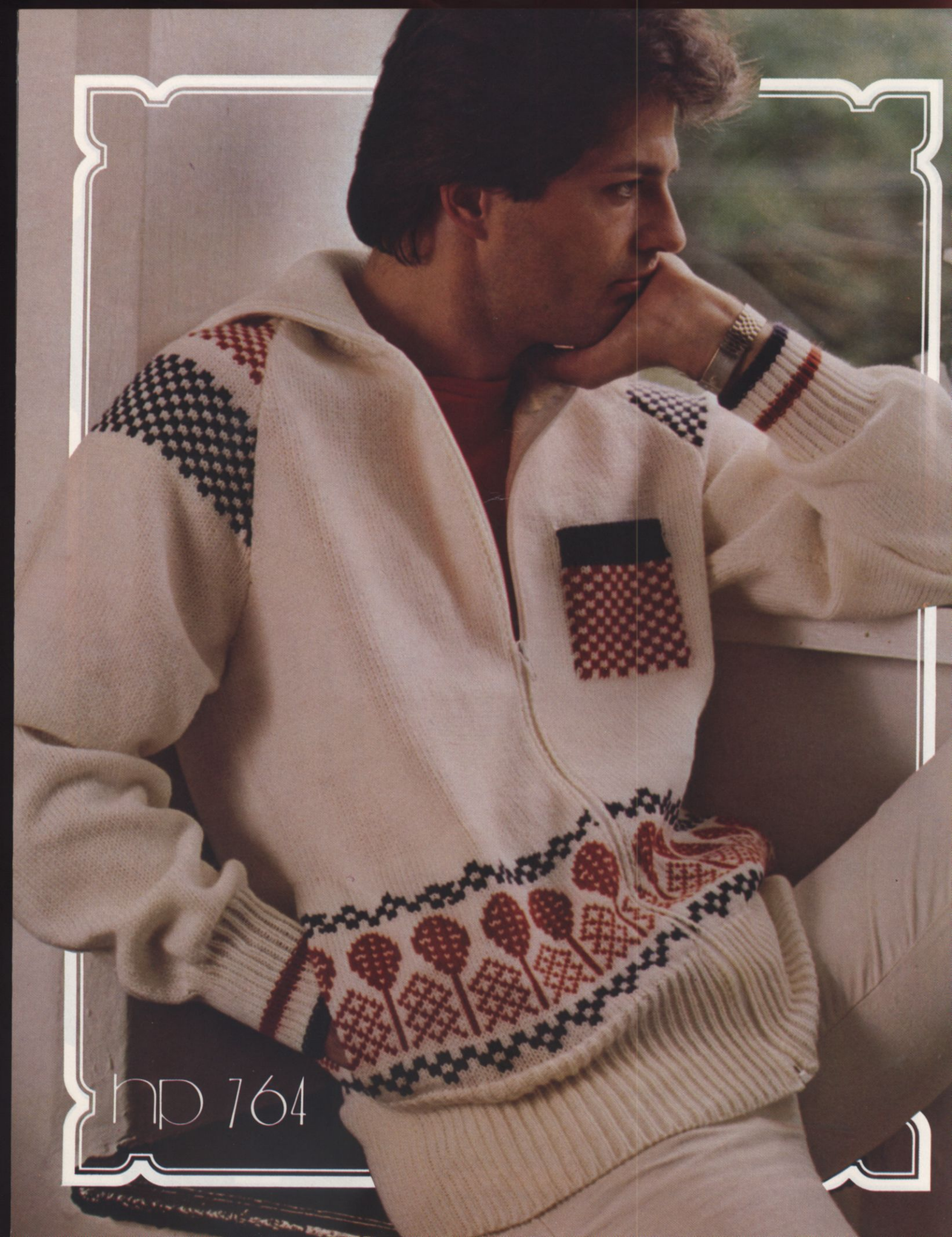
