


-  Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.

REPEAT the above for each complete row.













NEW CHERI CONE YARN

We introduced a new fine cone yarn a few months ago and called it 'CHERI'... Its knitting and wearing qualities were so good we decided to make up another cone yarn using the identical material and colors, but in a heavier weight.

This means that the original fine weight CHERI has a name change. It is now called 'PETITE CHERI'. The new heavier weight yarn is called 'CHERI'.

There are samples of all yarns in the new KNITTING YARN CATALOGUE which also includes a chart listing tensions and row gauges for all KNITTING YARNS.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

Decreasing a Number of Stitches Across a Section of Garment.

In this issue of KNITTING MAGAZINE, there are a number of garments where we are using an OPEN CAST ON for some sections. The reason is... it is easier to DECREASE stitches across the lower edge of a Sleeve for instance, than it is to work the Ribbing or band first, then increase a number of stitches across the row before knitting the main section of a sleeve.

For example DK 387: You need to decrease 16 stitches evenly across the sleeve after the main section is completed and you do this as you hang the open stitches back onto the machine in preparation for knitting the Ribbed band. Here is an easy way to set up the needles and figure the spacings for the decreases.

Following the Cuff Chart, bring 56 (60) [64] needles into working position. 16 stitches must be decreased, so you can figure you will need 17 spaces. We will work on the first size only for our example. If you need one of the other sizes, just do the figuring in the same way using the different number of stitches for your size band.... but the decreases of 16 sts. remain the same for all sizes.

$3 + 1 = 4$ (stitches)

This is a standard formula used in many of the books available on Charting and it really works. As you can see, 17 will go into 56 3x with 5 left over. What do you do with the leftover is the question?... Subtract the 5 from the 17 and you have 12, then add 1 to the 3 which equals 4... This means that you will use 3 sts. and 4 sts. Your answer now is 3 sts. 12x, and 4 sts. 5x. The decreases are made across the 56 needles (needles in working position) by bringing every 4th needle into holding position 5x and every 3rd needle in holding position 12x. It is a good idea to space them as evenly as possible - so bring every 4th needle into holding 2x on one side and 3x on the other side, then in the center, bring every 3rd needle into holding position. Count these holding needles - you should have 16 of them. You are now ready to hang the open stitches of the sleeve

section onto the 56 needles. Each time you reach a holding needle, hang 2 sts. on that holding needle. When all of the open sts. have been hung onto the 56 needles, remove the waste yarn (check to be sure you have not missed any stitches), knit 1 row Stockinette stitch from Left to Right, then transfer every other stitch to the Ribber and work the cuff.

COLLAR: VI

SANTA DOORKNOB COVER

Material: Small amount of 4-ply knitting worsted weight yarn in Red and small amount white Angora or yarn that can be brushed to simulate Angora. TENSION 9 or 10.

FINISHING: Secure all ends. Run thread elastic around opening of head. Weave the open sts. of beard together then remove the waste yarn. Sew in place (see picture). Glue small eyes on face, make large french knot for nose and make mustache with fine yarn (about 6 strands of white, 1" long), and sew in place. Make pom-pom and sew to top of hat.

HEAD: Cast on 17 sts. over every other needle. Work SHORT ROWS.

*ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 1 needle before knitting each row until 1 needle remains in work. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position, 1 needle until all are in work**. Knit 2 rows. REPEAT from * to ** 1x more. Bind off the crochet method.

BEARD: OPEN CAST ON WITH WASTE YARN... Cast on 6 sts. over every other needle. Knit 4 rows, then change to white Angora. Counter at 0. Knit 4 rows, then work SHORT ROWS. *ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put 2 needles into holding position, knit 2 rows, put 1 needle into holding position, knit 2 rows. Bring back into working position, 1 needle 1x, then 2 needles 1x. Knit 8 rows.** REPEAT from * to ** 3x more but knit only 3 rows at the end instead of 8. Remove the sts. on to contrast waste yarn.

FOOD JAR BOOT OR SOCK

MATERIAL: 2 oz. Knitting worsted 4-ply yarn in Red and small amount of White. Empty Junior size baby food jar or small tomato-sauce can. TENSION: 9 or 10. GAUGE: Not important.

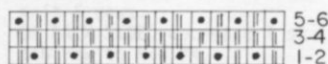
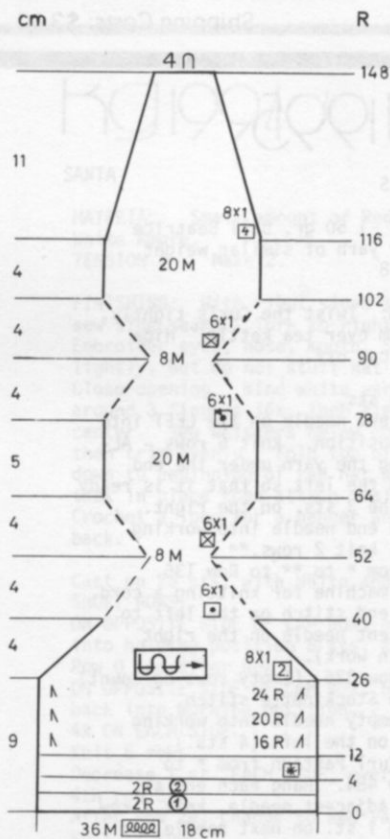
FINISHING: Weave foot seams on each side. Pull up cast on edge. Work 1 row single crochet around sides and tongue with red. For Sock, work shell stitch across top with white yarn. With White, make a chain 22" long and lace through eyelets and tie. Stuff foot with Polyester or dacron (do not stuff heel section. Put jar or can inside at heel and fill with small candies or candy canes.

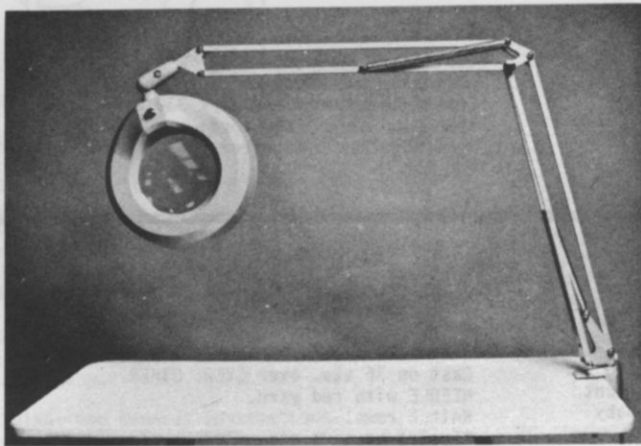
BOOT:

Cast on 36 sts. over EVERY OTHER NEEDLE with red. Knit 2 rows. Put Counter at 0. *Put the 2nd, then every other needle into holding position, knit 2 rows with white. All needles in work, knit 2 rows with red. Put the 1st, then every 2nd needle into holding position, knit 2 rows with white. All needles in work, knit 2 rows red.** REPEAT from * to ** 1x more. Continue in Stockinette stitch with red. After Row 16, make eyelet on each side by hanging the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd needle, leave empty needles in work. REPEAT the eyelets on each side after Rows 20 and 24. After Row 26, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 8x. After Row 40, work SHORT ROWS. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 1 needle 6x ON EACH SIDE. Bring back 1 needle OPPOSITE CAM BOX 6x ON EACH SIDE. Knit to Row 78. REPEAT THE SAME SHORT ROWS 1x more. Knit to Row 116. ON EACH SIDE, ON EVERY 4th row, decrease 1 st. 8x. After Row 148, bind off the remaining sts.

SOCK:

Cast on 36 sts. over EVERY OTHER NEEDLE with red yarn. Knit 2 rows. *Eyelet on each side, 3rd st. on 2nd st. Leave empty needles in work. Knit 4 rows.* REPEAT from * to * 2x more. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row to Row 20. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. EVERY ROW to Row 24. (20 sts. remain in work). SHORT ROW for heel. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put 1 needle into holding position before knitting each row until 8 remain in the center. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back 1 needle until all are in work. Knit 10 rows. REPEAT the same short rows for toe till 8 remain in work. Bring back 1 needle till all are in work. Knit 10 rows. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row till 2 remain. Bind off.

MATERIAL: 1 50 gr. ball Beatrice Silver or yarn of similar weight.

Knit in Curl Pattern from * to

** to Row 484. Hang each end st.

ANGEL

YARN: Amore.
1 50 gr. ball each of white & pink. Small amounts of yellow or brown for hair.
TENSION: 4. GAUGE: 17 sts. 26 rows = 5 cm (2")



FINISHING: With right sides together, sew up sides of head and body, turn to right side. Embroider face, then stuff lightly and sew up opening. Stuff body then work shell crochet across lower edge with white. Sew head to body. Cut strands of yarn for hair (yellow, brown or black) about 8 inches long. Tie in center. Cut 12 strands 5" long for back hair and front bangs. Sew bangs in place first, then sew center of 8" strands to top of head and arrange hair on each side and tuck in place if needed. Trim hair. Fold arms in half and sew center to back of neck. Bring hands around to front and cross (or arrange them as you like) and tuck in place. Gather wings in center and sew on back, covering the arms. Make a chain for hanging fold to make a loop and sew to back.

BODY: Make 2 in White

Cast on 7 sts. and work Stockinette stitch.
Knit 4 rows.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 4x, every 6th row 7x. (29 sts.) After Row 58, work SHORT ROWS: ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 2 sts. 5x ON EACH SIDE. Bring all the needles back into working position before knitting the next 2 rows. Knit 1 row Tension 10, then bind off the crochet method.

HEAD: Pink.

Cast on 19 sts and work Stockinette stitch and SHORT ROWS.
ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 6 sts. at Row 0 and after Row 1.
ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position ON EACH SIDE - 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x.
Knit 6 rows.
*ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position ON EACH SIDE 1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x.**
ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position ON EACH SIDE, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x.
Knit 6 rows.
REPEAT from * to ** 1x.
Bring all the needles back into working position before knitting the next 2 rows. Knit 1 row Tension 10 then bind off the crochet method.

ARMS:

Set your machine for knitting a cord. Use Tension 3. Empty rows DO count. Cast on 5 sts. with Pink.
Knit 6 rows.
Change to White and knit 84 rows.
Change to Pink and knit 6 rows.
Bind off.

WINGS: Tension 4 or 5.

Follow the Line Drawing for the needle set-up, then cast on over the 11 needles in work using White.
*Counting from the LEFT, put needles 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 9 into holding position.
Knit 8 rows (do not wrap the yarn).
Bring needles 6 and 9 into working position, knit 2 rows.
Bring needles 4 and 5 into working position, needles 6 and 9 into holding position.
Knit 8 rows.
Bring needles 1, 2, 3, 6, 9 into working position, knit 2 rows.
Put needles 3, 6, 9 into holding position, knit 8 rows.
All needles in work, knit 2 rows.**
REPEAT from * to ** to Row 108 (Pattern will not be completed).
All needles in work, knit 1 row Tension 10 and bind off the crochet method.

BELLS

MATERIAL: Small amounts of Red or Green or White Micaela.
TENSION: Change Tensions as given.

FINISHING: Weave the inside seam then the outside seam. Pull up the 2 sts. held on doubled yarn and tie securely. With basic color, make a crochet chain for a hanger and sew to top of bell. Hang small silver or gold bell to dangle inside.

Cast on 29 sts.
Knit 4 rows EACH with Tensions 1, 3, 5, 7, 12 rows Tension 9, 4 rows EACH Tensions 7, 5, 3, 1.
Hang the cast-on sts. back onto the machine to form hem then remove the doubled sts. onto strand of yarn.

VARIATION: Instead of knitting the 12 center rows as given, knit 4 rows Tension 9 with basic color, then put every 3rd needle into holding position, knit 4 rows Tension 9 using contrast color. All needles in work, knit 4 rows basic color. Continue instructions as given. You may also put every 2nd needle into holding position and use the contrast color for 4 rows.

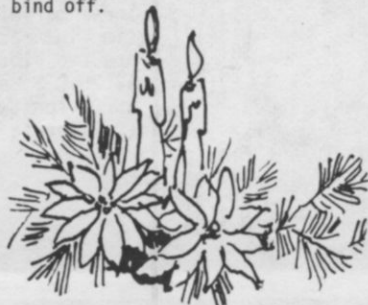

CHRISTMAS TREE

MATERIAL: Small amount Green Amore.
TENSION: 4. MAKE 2.

FINISHING: With WRONG sides together, pin sections. Begin at lower edge of tree section and work reverse single crochet around to base of trunk. Stuff lightly with dacron fibrefill, then finish crochet around trunk. Trim with Sequins. Make crochet hanger and sew to back at top of tree.

Cast on 3 sts. Knit 4 rows.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. (by bringing an extra needle into working position) every 6th row 3x, every 4th row 10x.
After Row 60, bind off 11 sts. beginning next 2 rows.
Knit 10 rows over 7 sts. After Row 74, bind off.

SANTA

MATERIAL: Small amount of Red and White Amore.
TENSION 4 Make 2.

FINISHING: With right sides together, sew side seams. Turn to right side. Embroider eyes, nose, mouth. Stuff lightly, but do not stuff hat section. Close opening. Wind white yarn around 3 fingers 16x, then tie in center. Sew whiskers below mouth, then trim evenly. Fold top of hat down to beginning of red hat and tuck in place then attach small bell. Crochet a loop for a hanger and sew to back.

Cast on 25 sts. with White and work SHORT ROWS.
ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 8 sts. at Row 0 and after Row 1.

Decrease 1 st. EACH SIDE, every 4th row 3x.
After Row 28, change to Red yarn.
Knit 12 rows.
ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st.
Knit 6 rows.
ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row to Row 74.
Hang the end st. on each side onto center needle and bind off.

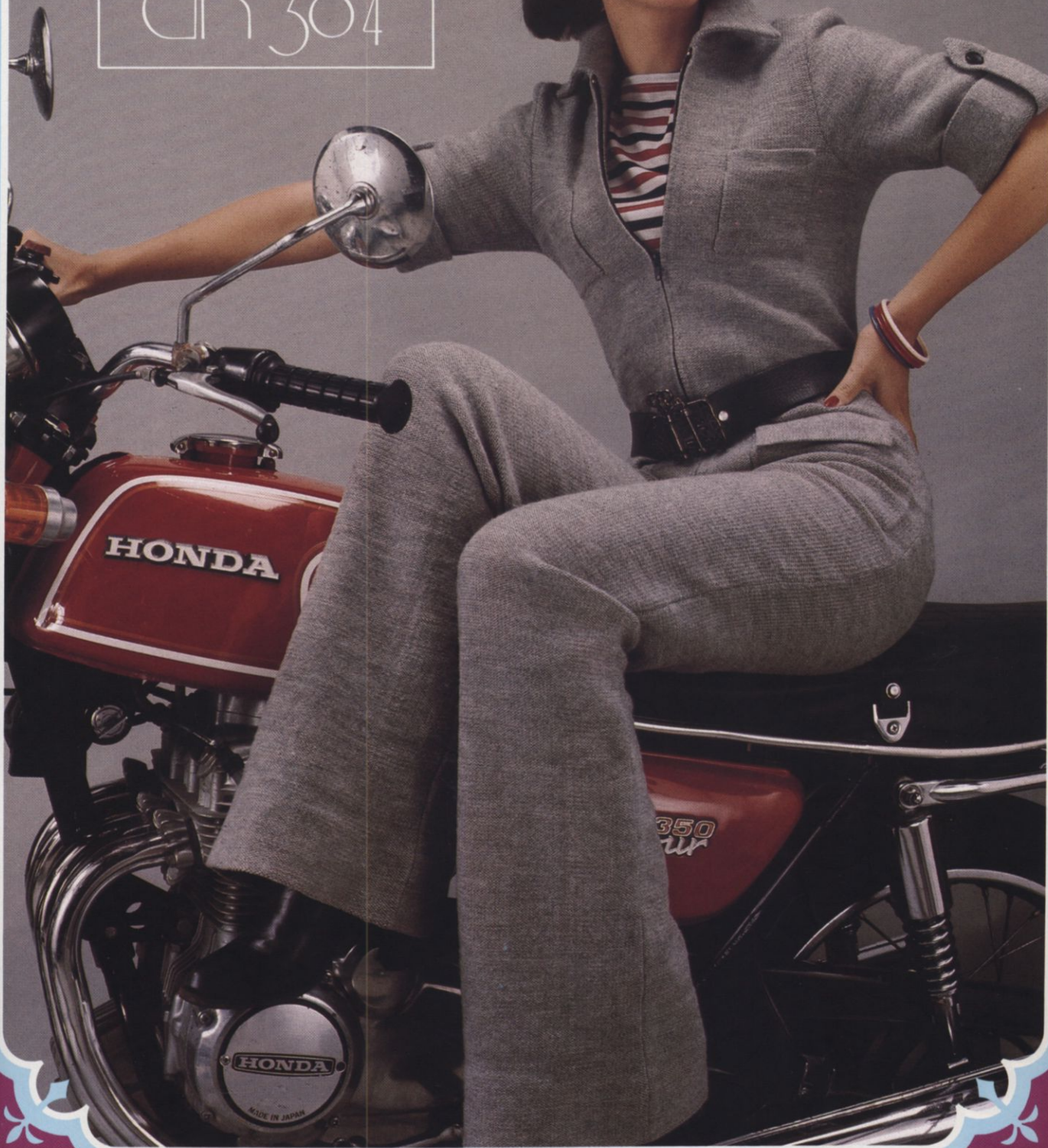

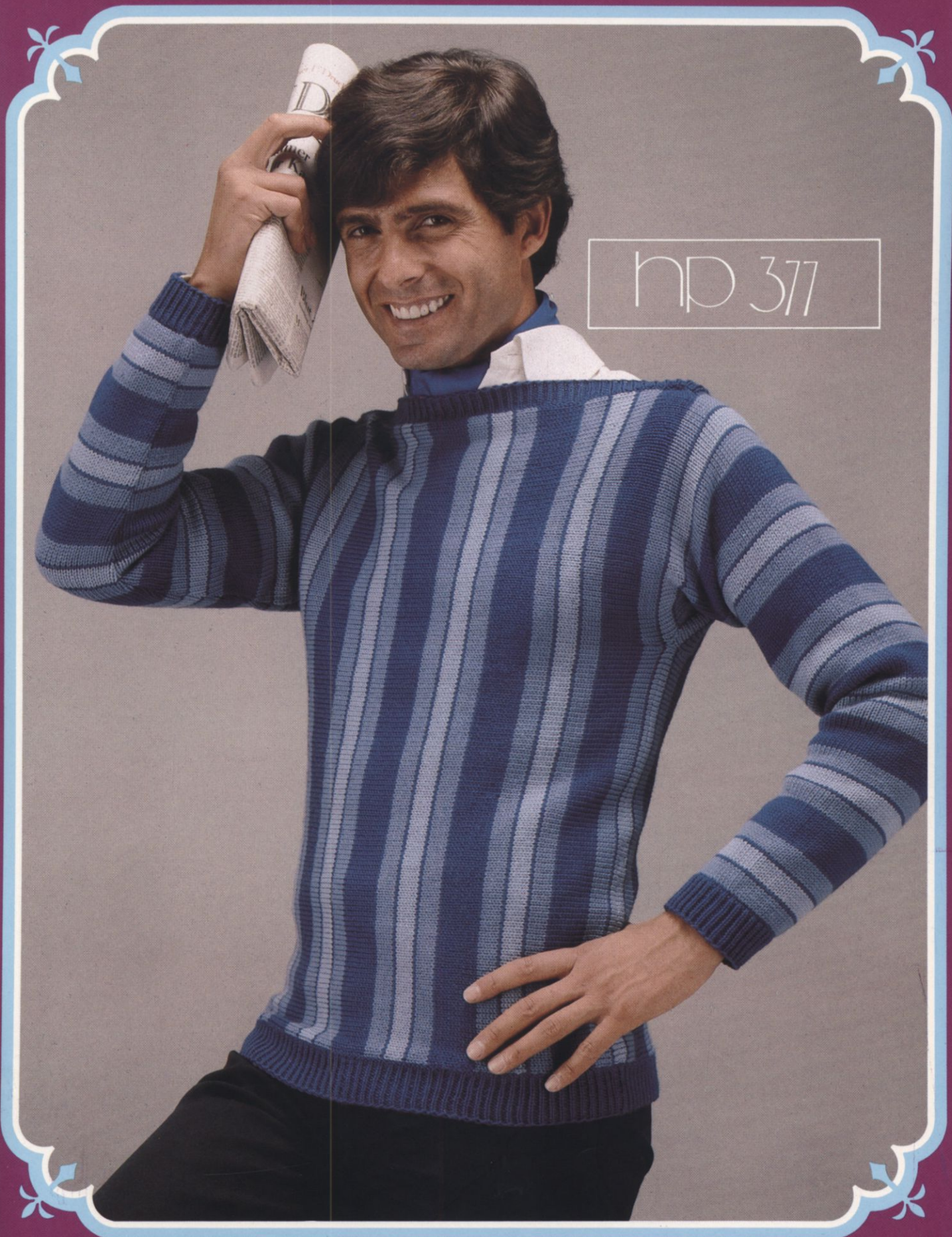
