Col. B. 1 oz. Robin 3 ply Bri Nylon.

Trousers: Col. B. 5 (5, 6) ozs. Robin 3 ply Bri Nylon.

6 buttons for jacket.

6 buttons for jumper

1 in. elastic (to desired length).

Finished measurements:

1 C.O.B.H. 68 (74, 80) sts. \* T8. K. 7. T10. K. 1. C.O.R. 000 \*.

2 70 (74, 78) rows straight.

3 Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows to 62 (68, 74) sts. C.O.R. 000.

4 Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 6th row, 3 times to 56 (62, 68) sts. 18 rows.

5 24 (28, 32) rows straight to shoulder.

6 Cast off 7 sts. at beg. next 4 rows, then cast off 4 (6, 8) sts. to 20 (22, 24) back neck sts. Thread up these sts.

## **Left Front**

(Repeat for right reversing all shaping)

1 C.O.B.H. 40 (42, 44) sts. As for 1 back \* to \*.

2 54 (58, 62) rows. On front edge dec. 1 st. and every foll. 4th row, 7 times, then dec. 1 st. every 3rd row 8 times. At the same time on left edge work steps 3, 4 and 5 as

At the same time on left edge work steps 3, 4 and 5 as for back to row 16. 18 (20, 22) sts. K. to 24 (28, 32) rows to shoulder.

6 As for back.

## Sleeve

1 C.O.B.H. 48 (52, 56) sts. as for back 1 \* to \*.

2 Inc. 1 st. on each edge every 28 (22, 18) rows. 2 (3, 4) times to 52 (58, 64) sts. K. to 68 (74, 80) rows.

3 Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows to 46 (52, 58) sts. C.O.R. 000.


4 Dec. 1 st. at beg. every row to row 18. 28 (34, 40) sts.

**5** Cast off 2 (3, 4) sts. at beg. of next 4 rows. Then dec. 2 sts. at beg. of next 4 rows. Cast off rem. 12 (14, 16) sts.

Press back and fronts; join shoulders. Rib band:—cast on 144 (152, 160) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T3/3. K. 4 rows tub. T6/6. K. 2 rows. Working from right edge cast off 4 to 7 sts. \* Miss 4 (6, 8) sts. Cast off 4 sts. \* Repeat once more \* to \* making 3 buttonholes. T6/6. K. 18 rows. Rib. transfer rib sts. to M.B.

Single bed Mc/s. C.O.B.H. 72 (76, 80) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T7. K. 2 rows. Make buttonholes K. 18 rows. M.D.E. 144 (152, 160) sts. With right side of work facing machine place side front to first 64 (66, 68) sts. back neck to 18 (20, 22) sts. Cast off up to this point, place remainder of sts. to rest of needles and cast off to end.

Press sleeves. Turn back hems of jacket and sleeves along foldline and stitch into place. Press. Stitch tops of sleeves into armholes. Join side and sleeve seams. Press all seams and press band, turning back collar, stitch to secure. Finish off buttonholes, sew on buttons to correspond with holes.



Right Trouser Leg (Reverse all shapings for left leg)

**1** Cast on 82 (90, 98) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T2/2. 4 rows tub. C.O.R. 000. T3/3.

2 Inc. 1 st. every 6th (7th, 9th) row 18 times to 118 (126, 134) sts. K. to 110 (142, 174) rows.

3 Cast off 5 sts. K. 1 row. Cast off 8 sts. K. 1 row. C.O.R. 000.105 (112, 131) sts.

4 On right edge dec. 1 st. every alt. row 9 times. 18 rows. **At the same time** on left edge dec. 1 st. every 12 (14, 15) rows. K. to 74 (84, 94) rows. 90 (98, 106) sts.

**5** Cast off 45 (48, 51) Ns. K. 2 rows. Cast off 9 (10, 11) sts. at beg. of every alt. row 5 times to end.

## **Trouser Waist Band**

Cast on 144 (152, 160) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T2/2. K. 4 rows tub. T3/3. K. 24 rows. Steam legs lightly, join front crutch. With right side of work facing machine, place work evenly along onto needles and cast off to end. Join back seam. Catch down waist band on inside, inserting ½ in. elastic (to desired length). Close inside leg seams. Press seams.

Front and Back Jumper

**1 Ribber.** Cast on 82 (90, 98) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T2/2. 4 rows tub. T3/3. K. 12 rows. Trans. ribber sts. to M.B.

Single bed M/cs

**1** C.O.B.H. 42 (46, 50) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T3. K. 12. T5. K. 1.T3. K. 12. M.D.E. T3. K. 1 row. C.O.R. 000.

2 K. 70 (78, 86) rows straight.

- **3** Cast off 3 (4, 5) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows to 76 (82, 88) sts. C.O.R. 000.
- **4** Dec. 1 st. each edge every 6th row 4 times to 76 (82, 88) sts. 24 rows. C.O.R. 000.
- 5 Start intarsia from graph at 000. On front knit 22 (26, 30) rows straight and cast off.

Press front and back.

## **Front Band**

**Ribber.** Cast on 68 (74, 80) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T2/2. K. 4 rows tub. T3/3. K. 3 rows.


**Buttonholes:** working 3 (4, 5) needles in from left edge, cast off 4 needles \* miss next 4 needles and cast off next 4 needles \*. Repeat working from right edge, repeat 3 buttonholes. T3/3. K. 3 rows. With right side of work facing machine, place work onto needles and cast off to end.


Single bed M/cs. Cast on 34 (38, 40) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T3. K. 3. Make buttonholes as above T3. K. 3. T5. K. 1 row. T3. K. 3. Make buttonholes as above T3. K. 3. M.D.E. 68 (76, 80) sts.


## Shoulder Ribs

- **1** Cast on 90 (94, 98) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T2/2. K. 4 rows tub. C.O.R. 000. T3. K. 16 rows rib. C.O.R. 000.
- **2** Thread up left 31 (33, 35) sts. and take off m/c. Cast off centre 28 sts. leaving 31 (33, 35) sts. K. 6 rows. C.O.R. 000.
- 3 Inc. 1 st. on left edge every alt. row 5 times, first inc. at 000, to 36 (38, 40) sts. 10 rows. Cast off. For left, place sts. back onto machine and repeat from 2 reversing all shapings.

For Single bed M/cs. 1 Cast on 46 (48, 50) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib. T4. K. 16 rows and continue from 2 as for rib.








## Sleeve

- 1 Cast on 50 (54, 58) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib as for 1 back. **Single bed M/cs.** 26 (28, 30) sts. as for 2 x 2 rib as for 1 back. C.O.R. 000.
- **2** Inc. 1 st. on each edge every 8th row 9 (10, 11) times to 68 (74, 80) sts. K. to 78 (86, 94) rows.
- **3** Cast off 3 (4, 5) sts. at beg. next 2 rows to 62 (66, 70) sts. C.O.R. 000.
- **4** Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 3rd row 6 (8, 10) times, then dec. 1 st. every alt. row 6 (5, 4) times to 38 (40, 42) sts. K. to 30 (34, 38) rows.
- **5** Cast off 4 sts. at beg. next 2 rows, then cast off 3 sts. at beg. next 6 rows, to 12 (14, 16) sts. Cast off rem. sts.

Press sleeves. Join top of back to shoulder ribs seam. Crochet round neck edge. Pin front band onto edge of shoulder, stitch tops of sleeves into armholes, securing band and ribs. Finish off buttonholes. Sew on buttons to correspond with holes. Join side and sleeve seams. Press all seams and bands.



# Top and Trousers



## **Materials**

Listers 2 spun 4 ply, crepe tricel with nylon

9 (9, 10) 20g. Balls Apple Green

3 (3, 4) 20g. Balls Sunbronze

2 (2, 2) 20g. Balls Mexican Gold

2 small buttons, elastic for waist.

No. 10 crochet hook.

## Measurements

Chest: 21 (23, 25) ins.

Sleeve seam:  $6\frac{1}{2}(7\frac{1}{2}, 9)$  ins. Length of top from back of neck:  $11\frac{1}{4}(12\frac{1}{2}, 13\frac{3}{4})$ 

ins.

Inside leg: 73 (91, 11) ins.

## Tension

T8. 14 sts. 20 rows over st.st. to 2 ins.

## Тор

## Back

With Sunbronze, cast on 82 (90, 98) sts. T6. K. 8 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T7 K. 9 rows, make hem. T8. K. 2 rows. Work from chart, starting with Mexican Gold (B) and then Apple Green (C), working in stripes as given in chart and dec. 1 st. at both ends of every 12th row to 74 (82, 90) sts. When 13 'stripes' have been worked and the two foll. Sunbronze rows, cont. in st. st. using Apple Green only, until work measures 7 (8, 9) ins. from hemline. Shape raglans. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows, then dec. 1 st. at both ends of every alt. row to 50 (52, 54) sts. Divide for back opening. Put left hand 25 (26, 27) sts. into pos. E. H.C.L. I (800 H.C.L. 2) and cnt. on right hand set shaping raglan as before until 17 (18, 19) sts. rem. Put on waste. Return to other side of back neck, cast on 2 sts. at centre edge, and work to match other side until 19 (20, 21) sts. rem. Put on waste.

## Front

Work as given for the back until 44 (46, 48) sts. rem. Put centre 10 (12, 14) sts. on waste and the left hand set of sts. into pos. E. H.C.L. I (800 H.C.L. 2) and shape neck as follows. Still dec. at raglan edge as before, dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next 8 rows, then cont. dec. at raglan edge only until all sts. have been worked off. Work other side of neck front to match.

## Sleeves

With Sunbronze, cast on 42 on 42 (46, 50) sts. Make hem as for back, and cont. from chart working until 3 'stripes' have been completed plus the 2 rows of Sunbronze. Change to Apple Green only and cont. in st. st. inc. 1 st. at both ends of every 6th row to 54 (60, 66) sts. Work until sleeve measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$  ( $7\frac{1}{2}$ , 9) ins. from hemline. Shape top. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at both ends of every alt. row to 10 (10, 10) sts. K. 1 row and put on waste.

## Neckband

Join raglan seams and press. With Apple Green, cast on 90 (94, 98) sts. T7. K. 3 rows. T6. K. 2 rows. T5. K. 2 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T4. K. 2 rows. T5. K. 2 rows. T6. K. 4 rows. Hang up the cast on sts. to form hem. With right side of top towards machine, hang up onto neckband sts. from back neck, top of sleeve, 12 sts. from front side

neck and centre front sts. and cast these off together, then continue on round neck, picking up 12 from side neck, hang up the sts. from 2nd sleeve and the sts. across back neck and cast these all off together. Work 1 row of double crochet around back opening making 1 loop on the neckband and the 2nd loop part way down opening. Sew on buttons. Join side and sleeve seams. Give a final press (not patt. parts.)


## Trousers

## Right Leg

With Sunbronze cast on 78 (84, 90) sts. and work as given for hem on back. When 9 'stripes' have been completed, cont. in Apple Green st. st. inc. 1 st. at both ends of every 10th row to 88 (94, 100) sts. Work straight until knitting measures  $8\frac{1}{4}$  (10,  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins. from hemline (adjust length here). Shaping: Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at both ends of next 3 alt. rows. Dec. 1 st. at both ends of every foll. 6th row to 72 (78, 84) sts. Cont. straight until work measures  $6\frac{1}{2}$  (7,  $7\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins. from cast off rows, ending with carriage on the right. Push up all needles except 36 (40, 44) at right edge of work into pos. E.H.C.L. I (800 H.C.L. 2) \*K. the row bring wool up round 1st needle in E. and K. back. Push another 8 sts. at left of sts. being knitted into E. \* Repeat from \* to \* 3 times more. H.C.L. I (800 H.C.L. 3) and K. the row. Trans. every alt. st. to adj. needles, leaving empty needles in N.W.P. T6. K. 16 rows. Cast off loosely. Work other leg to match reversing top shapings by reading left for right.

## To Make Up

Pin out and press on wrong side over st. st. parts only. Sew down waistband, leaving a small opening to thread the elastic through. Join body and leg seams, press lightly, with a warm iron over a damp cloth.

## Measurements


To fit 22 (24, 26) ins. chest. Inside trouser leg  $13\frac{1}{2}$  (16,  $18\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins.

## **Tension**

 $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. x 11 rows = 1 in. over st. st. T5.

 $7\frac{1}{2}$  sts. x 14 rows = 1 in. over 3 x 3 rib T3/3.

8 sts. x 10 rows = 1 in. over jacquard T6.



## **Jacket Back**

- **1** Cast on 104 (112, 120) sts. T4. K. 15. T6. K. 1. C.O.R.000 T5.
- **2** Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 13 (14, 15) rows 9 times to 122 (132, 142) sts. K. to 122 (132, 142) rows.
- 3 Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts. at beg. next 2 rows to 76 (80, 86) sts. C.O.R. 000. Trans. NS. to ribber bed for 3 x 3 rib. Change colour for jacket B. Start patt. See note.
- **4** Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 7th row, 4 times to 62 (72, 78) sts. 28 rows.
- 5 42 (50, 58) rows to shoulder.
- **6** Cast off 3 sts. at beg. next 8 rows then cast off 3 (4, 5) sts. at beg. next 4 rows. Cast off rem. 30 (32, 34) back neck sts.

NOTE: Step **3.** For **ribber** attachment, working from left trans., 4th to 6th NS to ribber miss 3 sts. and trans. next 3 NS repeat across m/c.

## N.B.

For jacket B with the 3 x 3 rib use the foll. On the m/c bring forward to E pos. the centre needle of every group of three. K. 4 rows with these needles forward. K 2 rows with all needles in B. pos. then bring forward the centre needle of the alternate groups of three and repeat as above.

Trousers A 8 (9, 9) ozs. Col. A. Lister or Lee Target. Knickerbockers B 6 (7, 9) ozs. Col. A. Tricel/Nylon 4 ply. 2 ozs. Col. B.



Jumper A 4 ozs. Col. A.

3 ozs. Col. B. Tricel/Nylon 4 ply.

1 oz. each of 2 contrast colours. Jumper B 1 oz. Col. A.

7 (8, 8) ozs. Col. B.



## **Right Front**

- 1 Cast on 52 (56, 60) sts. as for 1 back.
- 2 As for back to 43 (47, 51) sts.
- **3** As for back to 37 (40, 43) sts. C.O.R. 000. Trans. NS for 3 x 3 rib (change col. for Jacket B).
- 4 As for back to 33 (36, 39) sts. C.O.R. 000.
- **5** K. 26 (34, 42) rows to front neck. K. 1 row cast off 8 (9, 10) sts. on neck. K. 1. Dec. 1 st. every alt. row on neck edge, 7 times 42 (50, 58) rows.

6 Cast off shoulder sts. as for back. Repeat for left front, reversing all shapings.

## Sleeve

- 1 Cast on 72 (76, 80) sts. K. 86 (102, 118) rows.
- **2** Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts. at beg. next 2 rows to 60 (62, 64) sts. C.O.R. 000.
- **3** Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 3rd row 8 (9, 10) times to 44 sts. K. to 26 (28, 30) rows.
- **4** Dec. 1 st. on each edge every row 10 times to 24 sts. K. 1 row. Cast off. Repeat sleeve.

## Cuff

**Ribber** Cast on 60 (66, 72) sts. on col. A for jacket A or in colour B for jacket B as for 3 x 3 rib (see N.B.). K. 35 rows of patt. Cast off.

## **Cuff band Jacket A**

Cast on 15 sts. T4. K. 8. T6. K. 1. T4. K. 8. M.D.E. with right edge of cuff facing band, place evenly onto NS and cast off to end. Repeat for left edge of cuff. Repeat for other cuff.

## To Make Up

Press back and fronts. Join shoulders. Join bottom of side seams. Turn back hem and stitch.

## Front Bands Jacket A

Cast on 82 (90, 98) sts. T4. K. 8. T6. K. 1. T4. K. 8. M.D.E. Place right front evenly onto NS working through both thicknesses of hem. Cast off to end repeat for left front.

In colour A cast on 60 (65, 70) sts. Make edge as above. Place right front (from hem to beg rib) evenly onto NS. Cast off to end. Repeat for left front. In colour B, cast on

24 (27, 30) sts. Make edge as above.

## **Buttonholes**

From right edge cast off 4th-6th sts. \* miss next 2 (3, 4) NS. Cast off next 3 sts. \* repeat from \* 3 more times, leaving 3 sts.

T4. K. 4 rows. T6. K. 1 row. T4. K. 4 rows.

Repeat buttonholes T4. K. 4. M.D.E.

Place right ribbed front onto NS and cast off to end. Repeat band omitting buttonholes for left edge.

## Collar/Jacket A

Cast on 77 (83, 89) sts. as for 1 x 1 rib.

T2/2. K. 4 rows tubular T3/3. K. 34 rows with right side of work facing M/C. place front band to 4 sts., front neck to next 8 (9, 10) NS side neck to next 13 (14, 15) NS back neck to next 28 (30, 32) NS cast off to this point. Place rest of neck to remainder of NS in the same way. Cast off to end.

Jacket B As above K. 16 rows. Cast off as above.

**Pockets/Jacket A** Cast on 35 sts. as for 3 x 3 rib (see graph) in colour BT2/2. K. 4 rows Tubular T3/3. K, 49 rows of pattern cast off.

Pocket flap. Cast on 35 sts as above. K. 19 rows cast off.

## Jacket B Cast on 35 sts as above K. 57 rows cast off. Sleeves

Press sleeves and join cuffs onto sleeves. Sew tops of sleeves into armholes. Join rest of side seams and sleeve seams. Sew pockets  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inches from front edge and level with bottom of hem. For Jacket A sew on flaps 4 inches up from hem.

Press all seams, bands and steam collar.

## Jacket A

Sew in zip and stitch buttons onto pocket flaps, cuffs and collar.

## Jacket B

Sew 4 buttons onto band to correspond with holes.

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

- **1** C.O.B.H. 104 (112, 120) sts. T4. K. 12 T6. K. 1, T4. K. 12 M.D.E. T5. K. 1 row. C.O.B. 000.
- 2 K. 138 (166, 194) rows.
- **3** Cast off 5 sts. K. 1 row. Cast off 3 sts. K. 1 row 130 (158, 186) sts. C.O.R. 000.
- 4 On right edge dec. 1 st. every 4th row 7 times. At the same time on left edge, dec. 1st every 10 (11, 12) rows, 7 times K, to 72 (78, 84) rows.
- **5** Cast off 42 (45, 48) sts. K. 1 row col. \* H.C.L.'s III (800 H.C.L. 1) push 8 (9, 10) Ns to E pos. K. 1 \* row. Repeat four more times. H.C.L.'s I (800 H.C.L. 3) K. 1 row. Cast off to end.

Repeat for left leg, reversing all shapings.

Press legs join front crutch seam.


## Waistband

C.O.B.H. 162 (178, 194) rows. T4. K. 12 T6. K. 1 T4. K. 12 M.D.E. Place top of trousers evenly onto Ns and cast off to end. Join back seam, inserting  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch elastic (to desired length) into waistband. Join inside leg seams.

Press all seams.

## For Knickerbockers


- 1 Cast on 104 (112, 120) sts.
- 2 K. 68 (82, 98) rows.
- 3, 4 and 5 as for trousers.

## Cuffs

In colour B cast on 103 (111, 119) sts. as for 3 x 3 rib (see graph). K. 44 rows M.D.E. Press legs. Join front crutch seam. Place leg edge evenly onto Ns and cast off to end. Repeat for other leg. Waistband and make up as above. Insert ½ inch elastic (to desired length) into knickerbockers cuffs.



## Jumper A Back

- 1 Colour B. Cast on 87 (95, 103) sts. as for 1 x 1 T2/2 rows Tubular T3/3. 14 rows rib. Change to colour A. K. 4 rows rib. Dec. 1st. Trans. Ns to M.B. Set M.K. to Jacquard. C.O.R. 000.
- 2 T6. K. 66 (76, 86) rows Jacquard.
- **3** Cast off 3 (4, 5) sts. at beg next 2 rows to 80 (86, 92) sts. C.O.R. 000.
- **4** Dec. 1st at each end of every row 22 (24, 26) times to 36 (38, 40) sts. K. 1 row and thread up these sts. and take off m/c.

## Jumper A

Front

- 1, 2 and 3 as for back.
- 4 Thread up sts. to left of centre 0 and take off m/c leaving 40 (43, 46) sts. on left edge. Dec. 1 st. at 000 and at beg. of every row 10 (12, 14) times and then every alt. row 12 times. At the same time shape armhole as for 4 back to end 22 (24, 26) rows. K. 1 row. place left sts. back onto m/c and repeat from 4, reversing all shapings.

## Jumper B Back

1 Rib in col. A as for Jumper A. Trans. Ns for 3 x 3 rib (see N.B.).

# Tee Shirt and Trousers

## Colour B

2 T3/3. K, 90 (104, 118) rows.



**4** Dec. 1 st. at beg. of every row 20 (24, 28) times then dec. 1 st. each end of every row 12 times to 36 (38, 40) sts. K. to 33 (37, 41) rows and thread up back neck sts. and take off.

## Front

1, 2 and 3 as for back.

1 Rib. Cast on 45 (49, 53) sts. as for 1 x 1 rib T2/2. 4 rows tub. T3/3. 28 rows rib. Trans. Ns to M.B. C.O.R. 000. 2 Change col. T5. inc. 1 st. on each edge every 8 (9, 10) rows to 67 (71, 75) sts. K. to 88 (104, 120) rows.

**3** Cast off 4 (5, 6) sts. at beg. next 2 rows to 59 (61, 63) sts. C.O.R. 000.

4 Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 3rd row 12 (13, 14) times. Row 20 (22, 24) push Ns to left of centre to E pos. H.C.L. III (800 H.C.L. 1) on inside edge dec. 1 st. at 000 and every row 16 times, con. dec. on outside edge K. to 36 (38, 40) rows. H.C.L. I (800 H.C.L. 3) repeat for left of sleeve dec. on both edges. Repeat sleeve. Press back front and sleeves. Join sleeves top to armholes of back and fronts.

## Neckband

Cast on 137 (141, 145) sts. As for 1 x 1 rib. T2/2. 4 rows tub. T3/3. K. 30 rows. Trans. Ns to M.B. with right side of work facing m/c place side neck to first 23 (24, 25) sts., sleeve to 28 sts., back neck to 34 (36, 38) sts. and rest of sleeve and front neck to rem. of Ns. Cast off to end. Cross band and sew onto place. Join side and sleeve seams. Press all seams and neckband.



## Materials

Of Lee Target Duo 4 ply Crepe Tricel and Nylon allow 3 (3, 3) 20g balls Copper Bronze

6 (6, 7) 20g balls Apricot

3 small buttons for shirt

Length of elastic for waist of trousers.

## **Actual Measurements**

Shirt - Chest 20 (22, 24) ins.

Sleeve seam  $1\frac{3}{4}$   $(1\frac{3}{4}, 2)$  ins.

Back length 10 ( $10\frac{3}{4}$ ,  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins.

Trousers - Width of legs 10 (11, 12) ins.

Waist 19 (21, 23) ins.

Side length  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $9\frac{1}{4}$ , 10) ins.

## Tension

Over two colour work 8 sts. 9 rows T9. to 1 inch (unpressed).

Over st. st. 7 sts. 10 rows T8. to 1 inch (unpressed).

## **Abbreviations**

st. stitch; inc. increase; dec. decrease; alt. alternate; beg. beginning; C.O.R. carriage on right; postn. position.

## **Trousers**

Starting at lower edge, cast on over alt. needles 40 (44, 48) sts. with Copper Bronze. T8. and K. 6 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T8. K. 1 row. T9. Join in Apricot and knit (from chart) 10 (12, 14) rows, inc. 1 st. at beg. of every row. Knit one extra for 2nd side. With C.O.R. cast off 4 sts. at beginning of next row. Dec. 1 st. at both ends of next 4 alt. rows. Work  $4\frac{1}{2}$  (5,  $5\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins. without shaping, ending C.O.R. Putting all but last 20 (22, 24) sts. at right end of work onto nylon thread K. 2 rows on these sts. Bring next 20 (22, 24) sts. and work 2 rows on these 60 (66, 72) sts. With Copper Bronze only K. 1 row T8. Transfer every alt. st. to adjacent needle returning empty needles to postn A. K. 8 rows, T10. K. 1 row, T7. K. 8 rows. Cast off. Work second side to match reversing shapings. To make up - Press on wrong side, pinned out, with a slightly warm iron over a dry cloth. Join front and back body seams, then leg seam. Sew down waist hem leaving a small gap to thread elastic through.

## Tee Shirt

Back - Cast on 74 (82, 90) sts. with Copper Bronze and work 2 rows K. 1. Pl. rib at T4. Change to Apricot and work 6 rows, then back to Copper Bronze and work 2 rows. Transfer sts. to main bed, and using Apricot only T8. and knit in st. st. until work measures  $6\frac{1}{4}$   $(6\frac{1}{2}, 6\frac{3}{4})$  ins. from cast on edge (adjust length here). Shape armholes. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of every alt. row 3 times. Work without further shaping until armhole measures  $3\frac{1}{4}$  ( $4\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $4\frac{3}{4}$ ) ins. Shape shoulders. Cast off 7 (7, 8) sts. at beg. of next 4 rows and 6 (8, 8) sts. on next 2 rows. Cast off.

## Front

Work as for back until armhole shaping are completed. With spare yarn cast off centre 6 (6, 6) sts. Front opening. Bring forward sts. at left side of work. H.C.L.'s 2. Working on right side of opening continue straight until armhole measures  $2\frac{1}{4}$   $(2\frac{3}{4}, 3\frac{1}{4})$  ins. ending at neck edge. Cast off 9 (10, 11) sts. at beg. of next row K. 1 row. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. (neck edge) of next row, then dec. 1 st. at this same edge until 20 (22, 24) sts. rem. Work straight until armhole measures same as back. Shape shoulder. With C.O.R. cast off 7 (7, 8) sts. at beg. of next and foll. 2 alt. rows, then 6 (8, 8) sts. on foll. alt. row. Return to left side of front. H.C.L.'s 3 and work to match other side reversing shapings.

## Sleeves

With Copper Bronze yarn, cast on 54 (58, 62) sts. and work in with Copper Bronze. Transfer sts. to main bed and continue in Apricot only, T8. and st. st. inc. 1 st. at beg. of 1st and 2nd, 4th and 5th, and 7th and 8th rows. K. 2 (2, 4) rows straight, shape to top. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1st at both ends of next 16 (18, 20) rows. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 4 (4, 6) rows. Cast off remaining sts.

## Collar


With Copper Bronze yarn, cast on 96 (100, 104) sts. and working in K. 1 Pl. rib, T6. K. 2 rows, with Apricot, T5. K. 4 rows. With Copper Bronze K. 2 rows, with Apricot, T4. K. 6 rows. T3. K. 6 rows. Cast off.

## **Buttonhole Band**



Pin out pieces and press on wrong side with a slightly warm iron over a dry cloth. Join all seams, neaten buttonholes and bands. Sew on collar to come just to the bands as shown. Press seams. Sew on buttons.





Press back, front and sleeves. Sew the tops of sleeves into armhole and the saddle strap onto the back and front of the jumper. With right side of work facing the machine and working from right edge of needles, place the right half back neck to first 14 (16, 18) needles, front side neck to next 16 (18, 20) needles. Cast off band and neck edge together to this point, place the rem. of neck to rest of needles and cast off band and neck tog. to end.

Join side seams and sleeve seams. With No. 9 crochet hook, crochet round back opening at same time working through both layers of neckband. Sew in zip. Press opening and seams. Press neckband into curve to fit neck.

## Measurements

Chest: 22 (24, 26, 28) ins. Sleeve seam:  $8\frac{1}{2}$  ( $10\frac{1}{2}$ , 12, 13) ins. Length from back of neck:  $12\frac{1}{2}$  (13,  $13\frac{3}{4}$ ,  $14\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins.

## Tension

(Over st. st. when pressed) 7 sts. 10 rows at T8.

## Note

Mock rib may be used successfully in place of proper rib.

With green wool, cast on 82 (88, 96, 102) sts. T4. and knit. K. 1 Pl. rib for 10 (10, 12, 12) rows. Trans. sts. from front bed to M.B. T8. with grey wool K. 4 (4, 6, 6) rows. T9. using red as contrast, work from chart A; when completed break off red and using grey only T8. and work for  $3\frac{1}{2}$  (4,  $4\frac{1}{2}$ , 5) ins. (adjust length here). T9. Using green as contrast, work through chart B. T8. Using grey only shape armholes by casting off 2 (2, 4, 4) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. T9. Working from chart C and using red as contrast, dec. 1 st. at beg. of every row. When chart C is completed, K. 2 rows in green then using grey as contrast and green as background, work from chart D, dec. 1 st. at beg. of every row as before to 34 (36, 36, 38) sts. K. 1 row in green. Put on waste.

## Front

Work as for back until 24 (28, 32, 36) rows from chart D have been knitted. Put centre 12 (14, 14, 16) sts. on thread or waste and left hand set of sts. on a holder and continue on right hand set. Dec. 1 st. at raglan edge as before on every alt. row AT THE SAME TIME dec. 1 st. at neck edge of next 2 rows, then 1 st. at neck edge of every alt. row until all sts. are worked off. Work other side of neck to match.

## Sleeves

With green wool, cast on 46 (48, 52, 56) sts. T4. and work in K. 1 Pl. rib for 12 rows (all sizes). Trans. sts. from front bed to M.B. T8. with grey K. 4 (4, 6, 6) rows plain. T9. using red as contrast work through chart A. AT THE SAME TIME inc. 1 st. at both ends of every 6th (6th, 8th, 8th) row to 60 (68, 76, 82) sts. When chart A has been completed, change to T8, and continue in st. st. in grey wool for  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ( $5\frac{1}{2}$ , 7,  $8\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins. (adjust length here). T9. Working from chart B, and using green as contrast. T8. using grey, shape raglan by casting off 2 sts. at beg. of next rows. T9. using red as contrast, work from chart C, dec. 1 st. at beg. of every row (as on back). When chart C is completed, K. 2 rows green then using grey as contrast and green as background, work from chart D still shaping raglan as before until 12 (14, 16, 18) sts. remain. Put on waste.

## Neckband

Join raglan seams, leaving one back seam open. Pin out to size and press on wrong side with a hot iron over a damp cloth. When cool and dry, rehang work onto machine (with wrong side towards you) from back neck 34 (36, 36, 38) sts. sleeve top 12 (14, 16, 18) sts. from side neck pick up 10 (10, 11, 11) sts. centre front neck 12 (14, 14, 16) sts. side neck 10 (10, 11, 11) sts. second sleeve top 12 (14, 16, 18) sts. making a total of 90 (98, 104, 112) sts. With green wool, T7. K. 1 row, T6. K. 2 rows. T5. K. 4 rows. T10. K. 1 row. T4. K. 3 rows. T5. K. 4 rows. T6. K. 1 row (16 rows). Cast off loosely. To make up. Sew neckband down neatly on wrong side (to form a double band). Join remaining raglan seam, sleeve and side seams. Give seams a press.

C.O.B.H. 66 (70, 74) sts. T4. K. 6 rows. Select nos. 1, 3, 5, 7. Take lace carriage from left to right. T4. K. 6 rows. M.D.E. Press back, front and sleeves. Sew the tops of sleeves into armhole. With right side of work facing m/c and working from right edge of needles, place the right half back neck to first 13 (15, 17) needles, front side neck to next 10 (12, 14) needles. Cast off band and neck edge together to this point, place the rem. of neck to rest of needles and cast off band and neck tog. to end. Join side seams and sleeve seams. With no. 9 crochet hook, crochet around back opening. At same time working through both layers of neckband. Sew in zip. Press opening and seams. Press neckband into curve to fit neck.



## Sleeve

- 1 Cuff. C.O.B.H. 30 (34, 38) sts. as hem.
- **2** 112 (116, 120) rows. inc. 26 sts. 13 sts. on each edge. Inc. 1 st. each end and every 8th row. 100 (104, 108) rows. K. up to 112 (116, 120) rows.
- 3 22 rows. Dec. 14 sts. 7 sts. each edge. Dec. 1 st. each end every 3rd row. Cast off 1 (2, 3) sts. each end. Fin. C.O.R. 000.
- **4** 10 rows. Dec. 20 sts. 10 sts. each side. Dec. 1 st. each end every alt. row.
- 5 Cast off rem. 22 sts.

## Neckband (Smock)

With no. 9 crochet hook, crochet round neck and armholes 3 times in all.

Press back and front bodices and skirt pieces. Then place smock back onto the machine and then place on skirt part placing 2 sts. on every 4th needle. Leave 1 st. at each end, then count every 4th and place on 2 sts. Cast off. Repeat for front. Join side seams and shoulder seams. Final press. Attach pockets where required.

## Note:

On jacq. patt. at row 19, A is the main col, place and lay across yarn at 2, 3, 4 for 4 rows. Then B becomes main colour. Press buttons until row 41 then back to col. A.

# Dress and Sleeveless Waistcoat



## **Materials**

7 (7, 8, 9) 20 gm balls of Listers 2 spun 4 ply Nylon and Tricel Crepe, in main colour.

4 (4, 5, 6) 20 gm balls of Listers 2 spun 4 ply Nylon and Tricel Crepe in contrast colour. One No. 10 crochet hook. 2 buttons for dress. 2 buttons for waistcoat.

## Measurements

Chest 20 (22, 24, 26) in. actual measurements.

Sleeve length 7 (81, 101, 12) in.

Dress length from neck to hem 15 (16, 17, 18) in.

Waistcoat length from back neck to lower edge 10 ( $10\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ) in.

## Tension

T8. 14 sts. and 19 rows equals 2 in, when pressed.

## **Abbreviations**

St., stitch, dec., decrease, inc., increase, R.C., row counter, 000, set row counter to 000. H.C.L., holding cam lever, alt., alternate, rem., remaining beg., beginning, pos., position, foll., following.

## Dress

Back — With contrast yarn, cast on 105 (112, 119, 126) sts., T6. K. 8 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T7. K. 8 rows make hem. T8. K. 1 row. 000. T10. Thread up with main colour and using contrast as laying yarn, work from chart to R.C. 13. Break off contrast T8. Working with main colour only dec. 1 st. at both ends of every 4th row until 74 (80, 88, 96) sts. rem. Work without further shaping to R.C. 108 (114, 128, 142) adjust length here if required.

## Shape armholes

000. Cast off 5 (5, 7, 8) sts. at the beg. of next 2 rows, then dec. 1st. at both ends of next 3 alt. rows 58 (64, 68, 74) sts. Work straight to R.C. 18 (20, 24, 26).

## Shape neck

With spare yarn, cast off the centre 16 (18, 18, 20) sts. Put sts. at left side of neck into pos. E H.C.L. on 2. Decrease 1st at neck edge on next 7 rows 14 (16, 18, 20) sts. Work straight to R.C. 32 (36, 42, 46).

## Shape shoulder

Cast off 7 (8, 9, 10) sts. at beg. of next and foll. alt. row. Work other side to match.

## Back

Work as for front till armhole shapings are completed. Divide for back opening. Put 29 (32, 34, 38) sts. at left side of work into E pos. H.C.L. on 2 and work to R.C. 32 (36, 42, 46).

**Shape shoulder** by casting off 7 (8, 9, 10) sts. at beg. of next and foll. alt. row. Cast off rem. sts. Work other side to match.

## Sleeve

With contrast yarn, cast on 42 (46, 50, 54) sts. T6. K. 6 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T7. K. 6 rows. Make hem. K. 1 row. 000. T10. and work from chart to R.C. 13. Break off contrast yarn. Continuing in main colour only inc. 1 st. at beg. of every 7th and 8th row to 52 (56, 60, 64) sts. Work without further shaping to R.C. 66 (80, 100, 114) or length required.

## Shape Top

Cast off 5 (5, 6, 7) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st.

at both ends of every alt. row to 20 sts. (all sizes). Cast off.

## Sleeveless Waistcoat

Back — With contrast yarn, cast on 76 (82, 90, 98) sts. T6. K. 6 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T7. and K. 6 rows. Make hem. K. 1 row. 000. T10. Using main colour as laying in yarn, this time work throughout from chart as follows:

Work to R.C. 32 (36, 40, 48).

## Shape Armholes

Cast off 6 (6, 8, 9) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows dec. 1 st. at both ends of next 7 alt. rows. 50 (56, 60, 66) sts. Work without further shaping to R.C. 96 (100, 110, 120). Cast off 5 (6, 6, 7) sts. at beg. of next 4 rows. Cast off.

## **Right Front**

With contrast yarn, cast on 38 (42, 46, 50) sts. and work as for back to armhole shapings. R.C. 32 (36, 40, 48). Cast off 6 (6, 8, 9) sts. at beg. of next row. K. 1 row. Dec. 1st at beg. of next and foll. alt. row to 25 (29, 31, 34) sts. K. 3 (3, 5, 5) rows.

## Shape Neck

Cast off (at left edge) 9 (11, 13, 14) sts. K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge of every alt. row to 10 (12, 12, 14) sts. Work without further shaping to R.C. 96 (100, 110, 120).

**Shape Shoulders** by casting off 5 (6, 6, 7) sts. at beg. of next and follow. alt. row. Work other side to match, reversing shapings.

## Banding

Join shoulder seams. With wrong side of work facing

towards you, pick up along armhole edges and hang onto machine. 68 (76, 82, 90) sts. With contrast yarn T7., K. 6 rows. T10. K. 1 row for foldline. T6. K. 6 rows. Cast off. Work other armband to match.

## Neckband

With wrong side of work facing and using contrast yarn, pick up 26 (30, 34, 40) sts. along neck edge of front 24 (28, 32, 38) sts. across back neck and 26 (30, 34, 40) sts. along rem. neck edge. Work banding as on armholes.

## **Front Bands**

With wrong side facing as before, pick up 40 (42, 48, 52) sts. along front edge (including edging to foldline) and work as for armband. Work 2nd front band the same.

## To Make Up


Pin out all pieces to size and press.


## Dress

Join shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Press seams. Set in sleeve. Work 1 row of double crochet round back opening with main yarn, making 2 loops for fastening at same time. Using contrast colour, work 1 row of double crochet around neck edge. Give a final press and sew on buttons.

## Waistcoat

Sew down banding and neaten. Press while flat. Join side seams, press them. With contrast yarn make a loop at top edge of front banding, long enough to just go over button. Sew on one button at top of each band at neckline.
