HOW TO MAKE PATTERN STITCHES WITH YOUR KNITTER "AUTO L"

THE KNITTER "AUTO L" is a high-performance knitting machine which has a number of new mechanical innovations and its simple operation permits even a beginner to knit attractive PATTERN STITCHES knitted garments easily and enjoyably.

For all types of PATTERN knitting illustrated in this "KNITTING PATTERN" collection a operation charts as shown below. We will first describe how to read such a operation charts.

HOW TO READ THE OPERATION CHART

- * This mark indicates the position at which the button for the weaving pattern brush should be set. Set the button at either the "N" or "T" position according to the operation chart.
- * This mark indicates which of the carriage buttons should be depressed, if necessary. When "PLAIN" is shown on the table it is not necessary to depress the "PLAIN" cam button or any other button. When "Right & Left TUCK" are indicated, depress both TUCK buttons and when the "Right TUCK" or "Left TUCK" is indicated, depress either of TUCK button specified. When "Right & Left PART" are indicated, depress both PART buttons and when "Right PART" or "Left PART" is indicated, depress either PART buttons indicated.
- * This mark herein indicates the graduation on the tension dial at which the dial should be set. Adjust the graduations on the dial depending on

the thickness of the yarn used and your personal taste concerning the size of the stitches.

- * This mark indicates the position at which the change knob should be set. Set the change knob to any of the three positions - N, T and M.C - as indicated.
- * This mark indicates the number of the position at which the Holding cam lever (H.C.L.) should be set. Set the H.C.L. at any of the 5 positions as indicated.
- * This mark indicates the type of the yarn used for figured knitting illustrated in this collection. Select the type of the yarn according to your personal taste.

- * The marks \triangle and ∇ indicate the position at which the change lever should be set. When this mark appears, \triangle , shift the lever away from yourself and this mark appears, ∇ , shift the lever toward yourself.

All this indicates the order of steps of operation.

Note: The above lines denote the end-line for one pattern knitting and the mark \blacktriangle shows the position at which the pattern repeat regulator shall be set.

Set lever (S.L.) ... When a mark (\blacktriangledown) is shown in the set lever column, first swivel the set lever and then shift the other systems in order.

Direction of carriage movement (K.C.) ... The mark \leftarrow or \rightarrow indicates the direction of the K carriage movement and the K carriage shall be moved according to the direction of this arrow.

Direction of L carriage movement (L.C.) ... When a lace pattern, pull-up & lace pattern or weaving pattern is knitted, the L carriage must be used. Move the L carriage in the direction of the arrow.

Color of yarn (Y.) ... Main yarn in the yarn feeder is indicated by a mark (a) when the mark in this column changes, change the yarn as indicated.

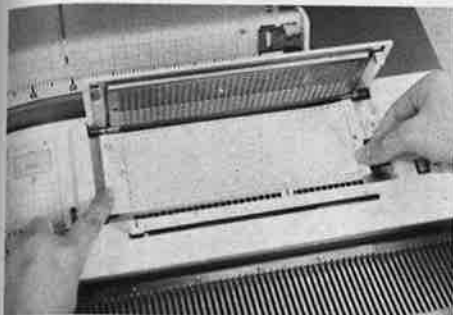
Secondary yarn & laying in thread(L.Y.)...When a multi-color pattern or weaving pattern is knitted, it is necessary to use a secondary color yarn or laying-in thread. When the mark b.c.or d is shown in the secondary color yarn & laying-in thread column, knit the pattern by laying secondary color yarn or laying-in thread over the primary color yarn.

Step indicating lever movement(S.I.L)...In the operation card for the lace pattern, pull-up & lace pattern or weaving pattern a step indicating lever movement column is provided, When this mark **▲** is shown in this column, move the S.I.L. one step to right by finger.

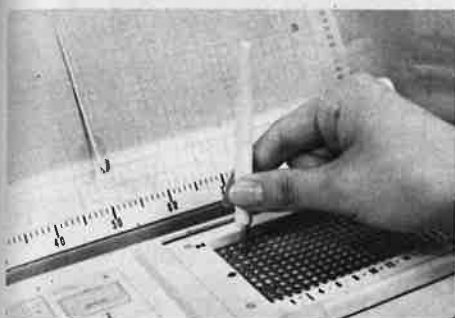
Hole punching positions for needle selector...The mark **○** represents the position at which a hole should be punched on the spare card by use of a puncher.

Symbols of stitch...The pattern is indicated by JIS marks as seen from purl stitches.

HOW TO PUNCH HOLES IN A SPARE CARD

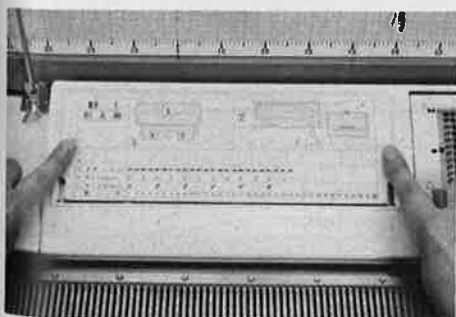


- (1) Push the Release lever to the right which will open the card holder.
- (2) Insert a spare card and align it with the right and left pins in the cassette box.
- (3) Close the card holder.
- (4) Punch holes on the spare card according to the appropriate positions for needle selection for the desired pattern using the puncher provided.



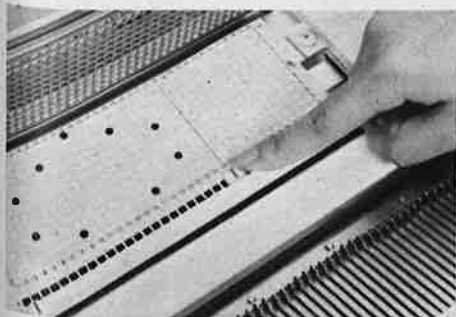
- * Hold the puncher at a right angle to the card holder.
- * Insert the puncher through the card holder hole as far as it will go and then pull it out being careful not to slant the puncher.
- * When punching a hole in the position of the S.I.L. (Step Indicating Lever), shift the S.I.L. a bit to do so.

HOW TO COPY REQUIRED ITEMS ON THE OPERATION CARD AND HOW TO SET THE OPERATION CARD IN POSITION



- (1) Copy the required items from the operation chart on the operation card.
- (2) When setting the operation card in position, put the operation card between the card holder springs as shown in the picture at the left.

HOW TO SET THE PATTERN REPEAT REGULATOR IN POSITION



- (1) Push the card lever to the right and the card holder will be opened.
- (2) Slide the pattern repeat regulator to the designated position indicated by the mark **▲**.

PULL-UP PATTERN STITCHES

Outline of the pull-up pattern stitches


Select the given needles by making the most of the holding position of the holding cam lever and move the carriage and then the selected needles are advanced to the E position to form pull-up stitches so that only the remaining needles can be used to knit. The pattern is knitted on the basis of the number of rows of pull-up stitches and changes in the lowering position of such stitches.

Features of the pull-up pattern stitches

The pull-up pattern is the sort of long-established pattern that finds application in a wide area. Its knitting texture has the charm of variety so that in many cases, the back texture is used as the basic pattern when the pull-up pattern is knitted by use of the single yarn while the front texture is used as the basic pattern when the pattern is knitted by use of laying-in thread.



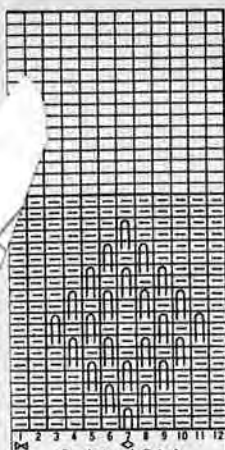
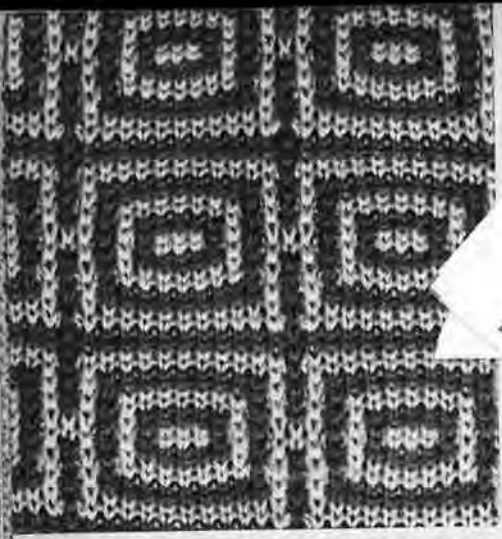
Preparation for knitting....Copy the required items from the pattern knitting table on the operation card.

- (1) Place the K carriage at the right end of the needle bed and set each of the systems in position as follows.

Tension dial (T.D.).....5	Change knob (C.K.).....N
Holding cam lever (H.C.L.).....2	Carriage button (C.B.).....PLAIN
Weaving button (W.B.).....N	Yarn in Feeder.....a
- (2) Shift the change lever (C.L.) to Δ
- (3) Push the release lever in the Pattern Center to the right to open the card holder. Next, set the pattern card in a position and set the pattern repeat regulator at 12, then close the card holder.
- (4) Punch holes on the pattern card from above the card holder by use of the puncher according to the appropriate punching positions for needle selection.
Punch holes at (1), (5), (9) in the 1st column at (3), (7), (11) in the 7th column.
- (5) Set the step indicator at the starting position (the first step of the operating process).

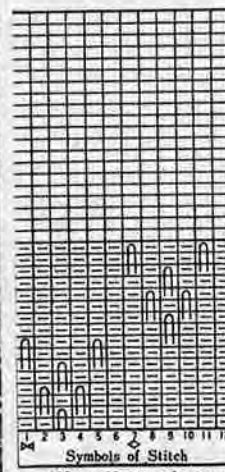
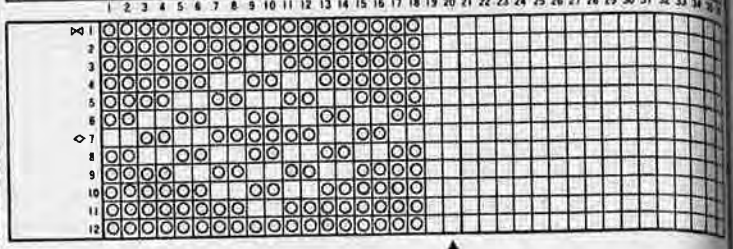
Steps of the operating process

1. Swivel the set lever and select the needles, then move the K carriage from right to left.
 2. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 3. Move the K carriage from right to left.
 4. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 5. Shift the H.C.L. to 3 and then move the K carriage from right to left.
 6. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 7. After swiveling the set lever, shift the H.C.L. to 2 and move the K carriage from right to left.
 8. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 9. Move the K carriage from right to left.
 10. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 11. Shift the H.C.L. to 3 and move the K carriage from right to left.
 12. Move the K carriage from left to right.
- * When all the 12 steps are finished, the step indicator will return to the first step automatically so that you can repeat the 12 steps.



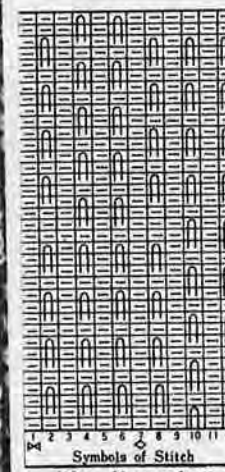
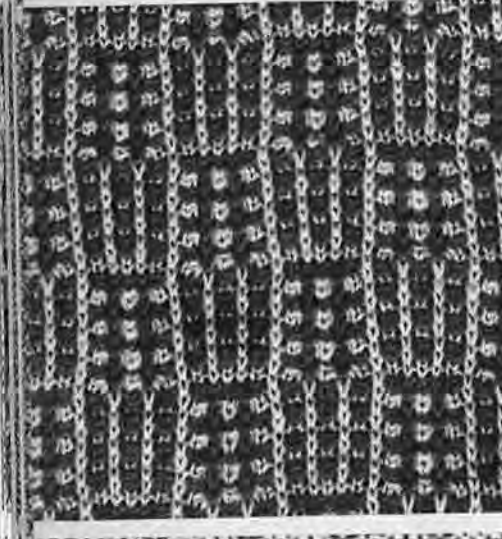
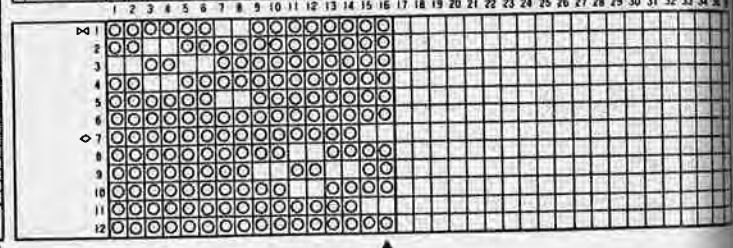

PULL-UP TUCK STITCH PATTERNS

Outline of the Pull-up Tuck stitch patterns

The pull-up tuck stitch patterns is knitted by making use of the holding cam lever and the TUCK buttons. The pull-up texture and tuck texture are knitted by forming the pull-up stitch on the forward travel of the carriage and the tuck stitch on the return travel of the carriage.

Features of the pull-up Tuck stitch patterns

You can knit the faciful and unique pull-up tuck stitch patterns by the simple operation of the knitter. The typical pull-up tuck stitch patterns popularly known as the novelty ribbing stitch pattern or as a bulk pattern.

How to knit the pull-up Tuck stitch patterns

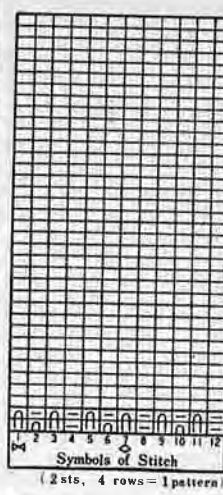
Preparation for knitting.... Copy the required items from the operation chart into the operation card.

- (1) Place the K carriage at the right end of the needle bed and set each of the systems in a position as follows while viewing the operating card.
 Tension dial (T.D.).....6 Change knob (C.K.).....N
 Holding cam lever (H.C.L.).....4 Carriage button..... TUCK right
 Weaving button (W.B.).....N Yarn in Feeder.....a

- (2) Shift the change lever to Δ
- (3) Push the release lever in the Pattern Center to the right to open the card holder. Next set the pattern card in a position and set the pattern repeat regulator at 8, then close the card holder.
- (4) Punch holes on the pattern card from above the card holder by use of the puncher according to the appropriate punching positions for needle selector buttons.
 Punch a hole at (1), (3), (5), (7), (9) & (11) in the 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th columns.
- (5) Set the step indicator at the starting position (the first step of the operating process).

Step of the operating process

1. Select the needles using the set lever and move the K carriage from right to left.
 2. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 3. Select the needles using the set lever and move the K carriage from right to left.
 4. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 5. Select the needles using the set lever and move the K carriage from right to left.
 6. Move the K carriage from left to right.
 7. Select the needles by use of the set lever and replace the yarn in the yarn feeder to the another color yarn(b), then move the K carriage from right to left.
 8. Move the K carriage from left to right.
- * When all the 8 steps are finished, the step indicator will return to the first step of the operating process automatically so that you can repeat the steps.



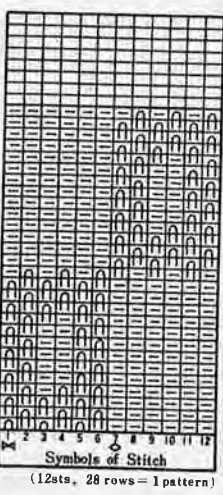
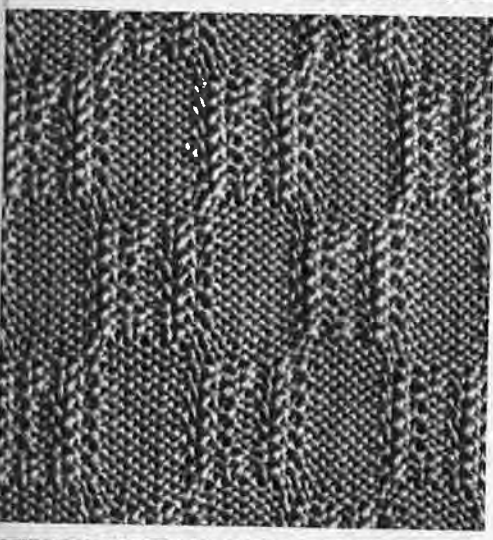

- (5) Punch holes on the pattern card from above the card holder by use of the accessory puncher according to the appropriate punching position for needle selection.

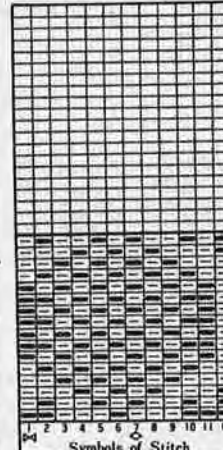
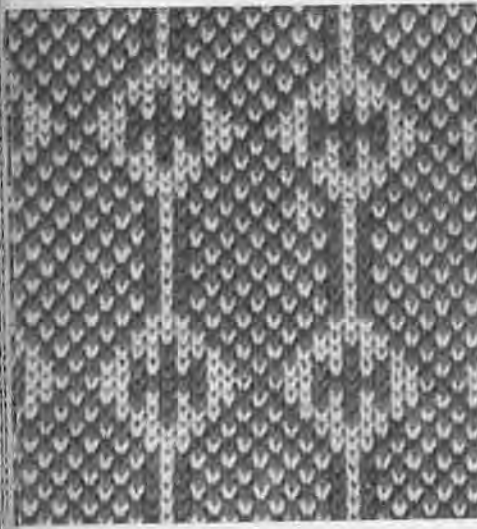
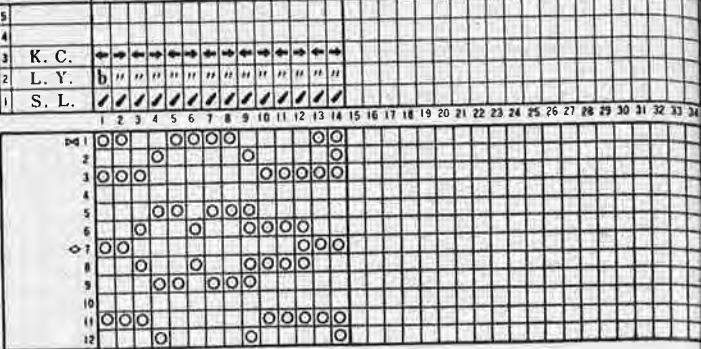
Steps of the operating process

- 1. Select the needles by using the set lever and put the laying-in yarn (b) into the left yarn guide. Then move the K carriage from right to left.
 - 2. Select the needles by using the set lever and put the laying-in yarn (b) into the right yarn guide. Then move the K carriage from left to right.
 - 3. Repeat the above process according to the operation card until the 22nd step.
- * When the 22 steps are finished, the step indicator will return to the first step automatically so that you can repeat all the steps.



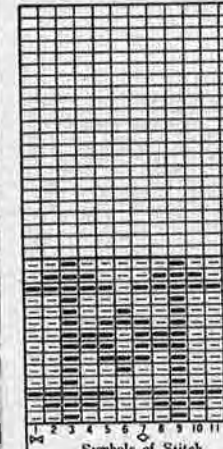
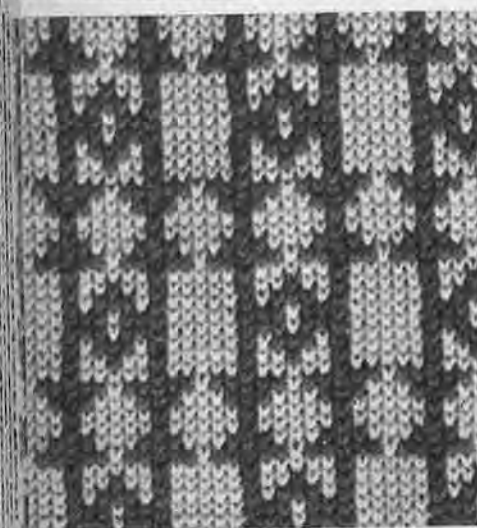
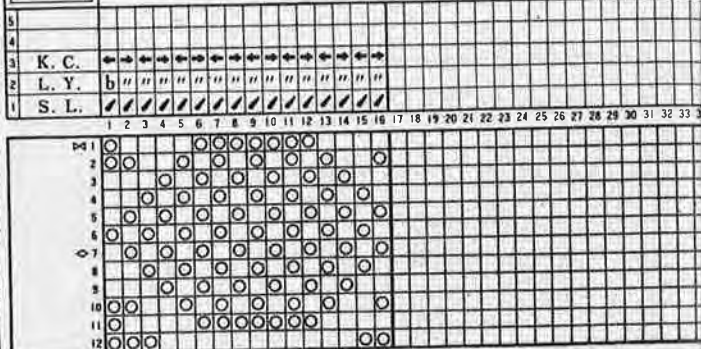

Weaving pattern and the materials

Magic of knitting! Look at the pictures of the Weaving pattern. All of them were worked by weaving knitting using the same technique. As you see these pictures, by changing the Laying-in yarn quite different effects are obtained. Therefore following the examples included in this Knitting Pattern Book, more than hundred of different variations can be obtained by combining different types of yarn.

How to get the best effect in weaving knitting

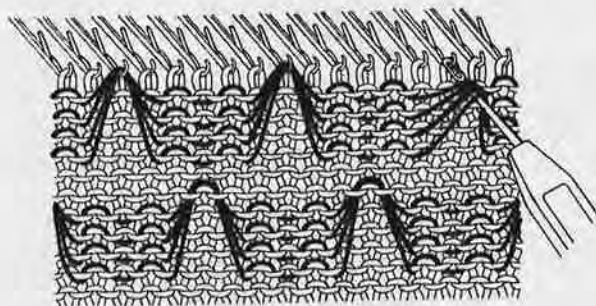
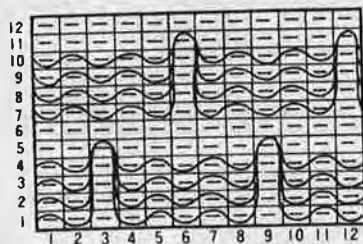
1. We recommend using a finer yarn for basic knitting and a heavier yarn or a fancy yarn for weaving thread. This way you will get the effect of an interesting contrast and at the same time you can reduce the weight of the garment which you are making.
2. Pay special attention to the contrast of the colors of basic knitting and weaving thread. Always match them up by doing a sample piece.
3. It is necessary to set the number on the tension dial according to the weaving thread. Usually one graduation lower tension is used for weaving than for plain knitting. Do not set the tension too tight or the weaving thread may catch in the stitches formed.

Special methods for making the Weaving patterns

There are three kind of methods for Weaving pattern knitting to get the fantastic pattern.

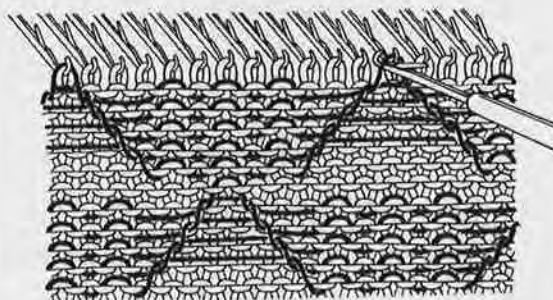
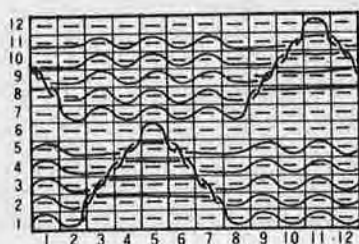
1. Pulling up the weaving thread.
 2. Knitting by using the Latch tool.
 3. Winding the weaving thread around the selected needles.

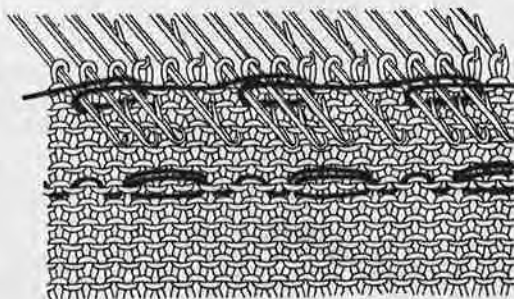
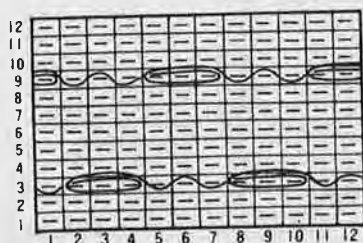

(2) Knitting



Work knit stitch of 5 weaving threads crossing in front of 7 stitches and put the last stitch on to the hook on the 6th row.

(3) Winding



Bring forward the selected needles to position E, and wind the weaving thread around the stem of the needles.

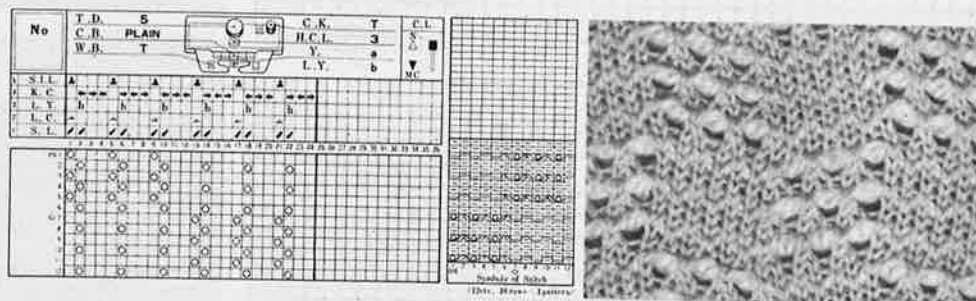
Outline of the Woven lace pattern

The Woven lace pattern is a special type of pattern which is produced by combining the weaving pattern and the lace pattern. This pattern is highly complex and makes the best use of the L carriage and the weaving thread knitting system.

Features of the woven lace pattern

The woven lace pattern has outstanding features of both the weaving pattern and lace pattern in combination. It gives a special attraction in which the woven yarn appears like dots from the base of the open work. The woven lace pattern has now become popular as a fashionable pattern.

How to knit the woven lace pattern



Preparation for knitting....Copy the required items from the operation chart on the operation card.

- (1) Place the K carriage at the right end of the needle bed and set each of the systems in a position as follows by referring to the operation card.

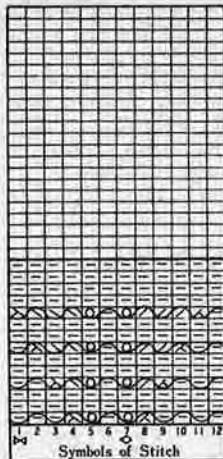
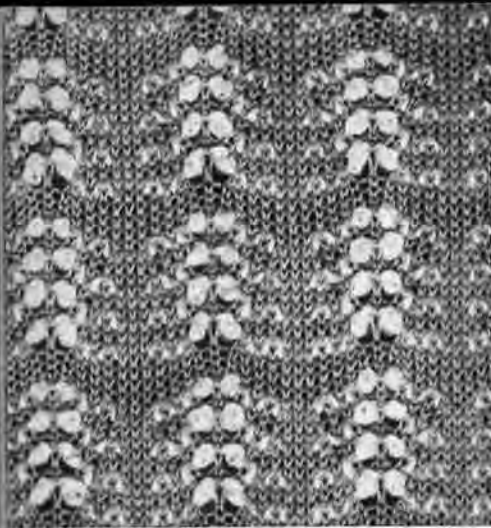
