BACK (both styles)

Step 1. Ribbers In Col A. cast on 149 (157,165,173) sts for 1×1 rib. TO/O. K 3 rows tub. T 2/2. K 29 rows. Trans needles to main bed *T7. K 1 row, C.O.R. OOO.

S/Bed. In Col A. C.O.B.H. 149 (157,165,173) sts. for 1 x 1 mock rib. T5. Knit 32 rows. T7. K 1 row, T5. Knit 32 rows. Turn hem *T7. Knit 1 row. C.O.R. 000.

Step 2. Knit 130 (136,142,148) rws. Cast off 6 (7,8,9) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. 000.

Step 3. Dec 1 st. at both ends of every alt row 14 (15,16,17) times to 109 (113,117,121) sts. Knit to row 90 (96,100,106).





Step 4. H.P. Push 6 sts. into H.P. at the end of the next 10 (8,6,4) rows. then 7 sts at end of the next 0 (2,4,6) rows. Thread up rem. 49 (51,53,55) sts.



SLEEVES (both styles)

Step 1. Ribbers. In Col. A. cast on 67 (71,75,79) sts. Knit as for step 1 of back.

S/bed. In Col. A. C.O.B.H. 57 (71,75,79) sts. Knit as for step 1 of back.

Step 2. Inc. 1 st at both ends of every 7th row 23 times to 113 (117,121,125) sts. Knit to row 168 (174,178,184) lengthen or shorten here. Cast off 6 (7,8,9) sts. at beg of next 2 rows. 000.

Step 3. Dec 1 st at both ends of every alt row 9 (7,5,3) times then every 3rd row 14 (16,18,20) times to 55 (57,59,61) sts. Dec 1 st. at both ends every row 0 (1,2,3) times.

Step 4. H.P. Push 4 ns. to H.P. at the end of the next 8 rows. Ret. ns to D pos at opp. end of next 2 rows. Cast off.



FRONT STYLE A (V Neck)

Step 1. Ribbers. In Col. A. cast on 159 (167,175,183) knit as for Step 1 of back to * Set m/c for patt. K 1 row. C.O.R. 000. (K rest of front in patt.)

S/Bed. C.O.B.H. 159 (167,175,183) sts. Knit as for Step 1 of back to * Set m/c for patt. T7. Knit 1 row. C.O.R. 000 (K rest of front in patt.).

Step 2. T8. Knit to row 118 (124,128,134). Cast off 7 (8,9,10) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. *Dec centre sts. to right. 000. Make note of pattern row.

Step 3. Working on right half only shape armhole edge as follows. Dec 1 st. at outside edge every alt row 15 (16,17,18) times at the same time dec 1 st. at neck edge every 4th row 0 (1,2,3) times then every 3rd row 25 (25,25,25) times. Knit to row 83 (89,93,97).

Step 4. H.P. Push 6 ns into H.P. at the end of the next and every alt row 3 (2,1,0) times. Then 7 ns 2 (3,4,5) times. Ret. ns. from left half to m/c and knit as for right half reversing all shaping.



FRONT STYLE B (Round Neck) Step 1. Knit as for Style A to * of step 2. 000. Step 3. Dec 1 st. at both ends of every alt row 15 (16,17,18) times 115 (119,123,127) sts. Knit to row 64 (70,74,78). Thread up centre 29 (31,33,35) sts (make note of pattern row). Working on right half only.



Dec 1 st. at neck edge very row 6 times then every alt row 5 times. Knit to row 83 (89,93,97).

Step 4. H.P. Knit as for Style A. Ret. ns. from lef hand and knit as for right half reversing all shaping. **NECK BAND STYLE A**

Ribbers. Cast on 76 (\pounds 2,86,92) sts. for 1 x 1 rib. T0/0. Knit 3 rows tub. T2/2 inc. 1 st. at right edge very alt row 7 times. Trans ns. to main bed.

S/Bed. C.O.B.H. &5 (91,95,101) sts. for 1 x 1 mock rib. T5. Dec. 1 st at right edge every alt row 8 times. T7. Knit 1 row. T5. inc. 1 st. at right edge every alt row 8 times. Turn hem.

With right side of work facing m/c place side neck to these sts. Cast off loosely. Rept for other side of neck

shaping on left side only. BACK BAND

Ribbers. Cast on 51 (53,55,57) sts. T0/0. Knit 3 rows tub. T2/2. Knit 14 rows. trans ns. to main bed.

S/Bed. C.O.B.H. 51 (53,55,57) sts. for 1 x 1 mock rib. T5. Knit 16 rows. T7. K 1 row. T5 knit 16 rows. Turn hem.

With right side of work facing m/c starting 1 st. in from each end place sts. from back onto these sts. and cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

Press all pieces. Join shoulder seams and neck band seams. Set in sleeves. Join rem seams. Give final press. NECK BAND STYLE B

Join one shoulder seam.

Ribbers. Cast on 139 (143,147,151) sts. for 1 x 1 rib T0/0. Knit 3 rows tub. T2/2. Knit 14 rows, trans ns. to main bed.

S/Bed. C.O.B.H. 139 (143,147,151) sts. for 1 x 1 mock rib. T5. Knit 16 rows. T7. K 1 row. T5. K 16 rows. Turn hem.

With right side of work facing m/c and starting 1 st. in from each end place neck edge to these sts. Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP As for Style A.



circular shawl

Materials

Argyll Ferntex. 1 cone col.A, 1 cone col.B. Measurements Diam. 43 ins. 109 cms. Tensions 7 sts x 10½ rows = 1 inch, 14 sts x 21 rows - 5 cms. T.D. approx 7.

CIRCULAR SHAWL

T7 With waste yarn cast on 140 sts. Knit 20 rows waste. Change Col.A **C.O.R. K 1 row. *Push 5 needles at right end into H.P. K 2 rows* rept from * to * to end of row (28 times). C.O.L. ret all needles to knit pos. K 1 row.**

Change to Col.B. Knit from ** to **.

Continue knitting sequence until 26 sections have been knitted, 13 Col.A, 13 Col.B. Knit a few rows with waste yarn. Remove from M/C.

TO MAKE UP

Graft edges together, remove waste yarn. Tidy up centre. Press. EDGING

T7. Cast on over 13 sts, extra st. on right, having 3rd, 5th, 6th, 8th, 9th,

11th, needles in N.W.P.

820 & 800 M/c's follow chart.

588 M/c * Push 4th to 10th ns into H.P. H.C.L.III. Knit 4 rows. H.C.K.I. K 2 rows * report from * to *

T7. Knit from graph until long enough to go around outer edge, fold in half and sew round edge.





CENTRE FLOWER: Knit 2

C.O.B.H. 39 sts. T6. Knit 2 rows. H.P. Place 5th and every following 6th needle into H.P. T9. Knit 6 rows. T7 knit 2 rows on all sts. T6. Knit 2 rows. Thread yarn through sts. and draw up centre. Join seam. Sew flower in centre of shawl securing edges each side of petals. Give final pressing.

SKIRT (4 panels)

Step 1. C.O.B.H. 97 (101 105) sts. T4 knit 12 rows T6 K1 row. Trans. every alt. st to right. T4 k12 rows. turn hem T5 k1 row. *Trans. every



alt. st to left. H.P. Push 5 sts at the ends of next 10 rows into H.P. ret. all nds to B pos 000.

Step 2. Dec. 1st at both ends of every 17th row 12 times (73 77 81) sts knit to row 204. 000

Step 3. Dec. 1st at both ends of every 6th row 12 (13 14) times to 51 (55 59) sts k to row 76 (82 88). Place sts on waste yarn. Rept panel 3 more times. Press all pieces join two fronts and two backs.

Step 1. C.O.B.H. 141 (149 157) sts. Knit as for step 1 of skirt to *H.P. Push 10 sts into H.P. at the end of the next 8 rows. ret. all nds to B pos.000.

Step 2. Dec. 1 st at both ends of every 10th row 8 times at the same time K patt. as follows. K8 rows. Trans every alt. nds to right. K4 rows K26 rows of patt. K2 rows. Trans. every alt. sts to right. K4 rows. K26 rows of patt. K to row 94. 125 (133 141) sts. Holes for belt. Starting from left edge trans 2 & 4 (6 & 7, 3 & 5)th sts to right. * miss 5 nds trans 6 & 8th sts to right rept. from * to end. K to row 102.000.

Step 3. Inc. 1st at both ends of the every 22 (24 26)th row 4 times to 133 (141 149) sts k to row 74 (80 86). Cast off 4 sts. at beg of next 2 rows.000.

Step 4. Dec 1st at both ends of every row 2 times. Dec. 1st at both ends of every alt. row $4(5\ 6)$ times. 113 (119 125) sts k 10 rows. Inc. 1st at both ends next and every 8th row 6 times to 125 (131 137) sts. k to row 64 (68 74).

Step 5. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 8 rows. Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 4 (2 2) rows. Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 8 (8 4) rows. Cast off 6 sts at beg. of next 0 (2 6) rows. cont. on rem. 47 (49 51) sts. Trans every alt. sts to right K1 row. Mark end sts. with waste yarn. T4 knit 12 rows. T6 K1 row. Trans. every alt. sts to right. T4 k12 rows. Turn hem picking up loops from marked row. Cast off.



FRONT

Knit as for back to row 40 (46 52) of step 3. Trans. centre sts. to right working on right half only continue shaping as for back on right edge

only at the same time shape neck edge as follows. Dec. 1 st. at left edge every alt. row 15 (14 11) times. Dec. 1 st at neck edge every 3rd row 27 (29 33) times. Knit to end of step 4. 20 (22 24) sts. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next and every alt. row 4 times. Cast off 4 sts at beg. of next and every alt. row 2 (1 0) times. Cast of 6 st at beg. of next and every alt. row 0 (1 2) times. Ret. sts from left rept. as for right half rev. all shaping.

Neck lace insert

Step 1. Starting on 3nd to left of centre 0 C.O.B.H. 61 (65 69) sts. T4 dec 1st at left edge every alt. row 6 times. T6 k row trans. every alt. sts to right T4 inc. 1 st at left edge every alt. row 6 times. T5 k 1 row. Trans. every alt. st. to right 000.

Step 2. Inc. 1 st at left edge every alt. row at the same time. K4 rows. K 26 rows of lace patt. K2 rows. Trans every alt. st. to right K2 row.

Editor:

We received an extremely interesting letter from Mrs Bond that 77 (81 85) sts. Knit a few rows. with waste yarn. Remove work from m/c and replace with wrong side facing m/c. With right side of work facing m/c place left neck edge to these sts cast off loosely. Rept. for right neck starting 4 sts to right of centre 0 and shaping on right edge. Press all pieces. Join shoulder seams.

Armbands

C.O.B.H. 99 (107 115) sts. T4 Push 4 nds into H.P. at the end of the next 6 rows. Ret. all nds to B pos. (R.C. 8) T6 k1 row trans every alt. sts to right T4 push 4 nds into H.P. at the end of the next 6 rows. K2 rows ret. all nds to B pos. Turn hem. With right side of work facing m/c place armhole edge to these sts. cast off loosely. Rept. for other armhole. Join all rem. seams. Give final press. Tie belt. C.O.B.H. 4 sts T3 depress right part button, knit till cord measures 60 ins. Thread cord through waist line.

To fit 16 (18,20) inch chest. Materials

6 x 25g balls, Lee Target Lullaby Fairy Fondants, D.K. Courtelle. 2 x 25g balls, Lee Target Baby Titania D.K. Courtelle and Nylon. 2 buttons, 1 size 8 crochet hook.

Tension

6½ sts and 10 rows 0 one inch over plain and M.C. knitting.

Pattern card no. 9 on 820 machine from basic set.

Pattern as diagram on 800 machine.





TROUSERS Knit 2

Step 1. Cast on 62 (68, 74) sts by hand in main yarn. Knit 9 rows. Set for pattern. Knit 1 row. (Total 10 rows).

Step 2. Knit 24 rows. Change back to main yarn for st.st. Knit to 50 (60,70) rows.

Step 3. 000. Inc. 1 st. each side every 3 rows to 18 rows. 74 (80, 86) sts. Knit 2 rows (Total 20 rows).

Step 4. Shape crutch. 000. Cast off 4 sts beg next 2 rows. 66 (72,78) sts. Dec. 1 st. each end of every alt row to 8 rows. 60 (66,72) sts. Dec. 1 st. each end of every 14 (15,16) rows to 64 (68, 72) rows. 52(58,64) sts. Knit to 65 (70,75) rows. Place all sts. on st. holder or W.wl.



BACK: Knit one Step 1. Pick up 39 (43,49) sts. from each leg, centre back in centre of machine, in main yarn. Cast on 1 st. extra on each side. 80 (88,100) sts. altogether. Knit 30 (32,34) rows.

Step 2. Armholes. OOO. Push all but 14 (15,16) Ns on right of

knitting to hold position. Knit 1 row. C.O.L. Cast off 8 sts. on left



of knitted sts. 6 (7,8) sts. remaining in knit position. Knit 1 row. COR. 2 rows knitted. Knit to 6 rows. Make buttonhole. Push 3 (3,4) sts. to hold position on left edge of sts. being knitted. Knit 8 rows on remaining 3 (4,4) sts. Push these sts. to hold position. Return the 3 (3,4) sts. on left to knit position and knit 8 rows to form buttonhole. Knit 6 row more on all 6 (7,8) sts. 20 rows. Cast off these sts.

Step 3. 000. Place carriage on left of machine and repeat step 2 on this side. 52 (58,68) sts.

Step 4. 000. Return carriage to right side of machine. Return Ns on right of centre to knit position. On these 26 (29,34) sts. dec 1 sts. each side of every other row to 20 (22, 26) rows. 6 (7,8) sts. Knit to 70 (74,80) rows. Cast off.

Step 5. Repeat step 4 on remaining sts.



BIB: Knit one.

In main yarn pick up remaining sts. on front of legs. Centre front in centre of machine. Cast on 1 st. at each end. 28 (32,34) sts. Knit 1

1 row. Knit pattern as hem on ankle, fold at bottom on M.C. ankle to 50 (52,54) rows. Cast off. TO MAKE UP:

Step 1. Lightly press all pieces. Step 2. Stitch inside leg seams and seams, they come on the front of

row. Set for M.C. for pattern. Knit crutch seam. Stitch up hem on knitting.

139,147) sts. for 1x1 rib TO/O knit 3 rows Tub. T 4/4 knit 26 rows. Trans. sts. to main bed. 000 S/bed m/c Cast on alt, nds for 1x1 rib 123 (131,139,147) sts. T4 knit 42 rows.

Turn hem. 000.

Step 2. T7 Inc. 1st at both ends every 12 (12, 13, 13)th row 8(8, 7, 7) times to 139 (147, 153, 161) sts. knit to row 100. Cast off 5 (6, 6, 6) sts at beg. of next 2 rows. 000.

Step 3. Cast off 3 (3,3,4) sts. at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1st. at both ends of every alt. row 5 (6,6,7) times. Dec. 1st at both ends of every 3rd row 5 times. 103 (107, 113,117) sts. Knit to row 106 (110, 116,122).

Step 4. Cast off 6 sts. at beg of next 10 (8,4,2) rows. Cast off 7 sts. at beg. of next 0 (2,6,8) rows. Place





Aran Style Patterns from Jones

Aran knitting effects are achieved by using a stocking-stitch pattern and adding the design by applying knitting roulets and bobbles before sewing up the garment.

The main points are as follows.

Step 1. Either the plain side or the purl side of the knitting may be used as the 'right' side of the garment.

Step 2. Roulets, or tubular, knitting are used to make the patterns and these are made in varying widths to give different effects. In each pattern the number of sts. used for roulets are given in instructions. Using same wool and same tension as for main garment, cast onto 3,4, or 6 sts., depending on effect required. Depress right part-button. Pulling down roulet with Lt. hand knit to required length & cast off. (Roulets are knitted in one length & cut as needed.)

Step 3. Bobbles are also used. Cast onto 6 sts. *K.7 Rs. With w.wl. K.1 row by hand. Leaving at least 9 ins. of wool handing at edge for sewing up, repeat from * for each bobble required. Cut strands left for sewing up. Press strip of knitting to prevent unravelling. Pull out W.wl. thus separating bobbles. Using darning needle thread strand of wool through each st. at top along side, through each st. at bottom and up other side.

Draw up bobble & secure threads. (Do not cut off as they are used for attaching bobbles to garment.)

Step 4. The roulets are used to make pattern, e.g. diamond pattern using 2 lengths of roulets and bobbles, open cables using 2 lengths of wider roulets, closed cable, alternate cable & diamond pattern with bobbles, and half cables with bobbles. (as illustrated in photographs)

Step 5. Choose the side of knitting to be right side, & decide on the type of trimming to be used. To estimate the amount of roulet required, measure the length of pattern panel & multiply by 3 for each strip of cable or diamond, or by $1\frac{1}{2}$ for zig-zag or half cable.

Knit the garment pieces, do not sew up. Knit the roulets & bobbles.

Press the garment pieces & pin out to shape onto piece of foam or ironing board. Mark out lines for pattern with pins, using tapemeasure for accurate spacing, Pin the roulets in place taking care to cross over the roulets in the correct position to create a balanced pattern, latch down the roulets loosely in place using wool of main garment, this can be done on wrong side using loose running thread. At ends of roulets, thread-up sts, and secure to garment. Pin bobbles in position & using ends of wool secure in place. When all pieces of garments have been decorated, sew up in the usual way.



Materials

No chart has been included for these m/c but as long as the correct tension is maintained any fairisle pattern can be used. **Step 1.** In col B C.O.B.H. 85 sts. Starting 61 sts. to left of centre 0 and rem sts. to right of centre 0. T6 dec. 1st at right edge of every alt. row 5 times. T8 k 1 row T6 inc. 1st at right edge every alt. row 5 times. Turn hem T9 set m/c for patt. k 1 row. 000 C.O.R.

Step 2. With Col A in main feed and Col B as contrast. inc. 1 st. at right edge every alt. row 11 times, knit to row 50. 000 (96 sts.) C.O.R. Step 3. Cast on 20 sts. at beg of next row. Inc. 1st at right edge every alt. row 15 times (131 sts.). Knit to row 650, cease pattern. In col B T6 inc. 1 st. at right edge every alt. row 5 times T8 k 1 row T6 dec. 1 st. at right edge every alt. row 5 times. Turn hem by picking up loops from first row of Col. B. Cast off loosely. Knit other half of cover to match reversing all shaping and starting 61 sts. to right of centre O.

EDGINGS

In Col. B C.O.B.H. 189 sts. T6 k 10 rows T8 k 1 row T6 k 10 rows turn hem, with right side of work facing m/c and starting 1 st. in from each end place bottom half of edge to these sts. (From point A to point B on chart) Rept. for other half. Edging for top half.

In col. B C.O.B.H. 189 sts. T6 inc. 1 st. at right edge every alt. row 5 times T8 k 1 row T6 dec. 1st at right edge every alt. row 5 times. Turn hem. With right side of work facing m/c and 1st in from each end place left top half (from point b to point c on chart) edge to these sts. cast off loosely. Rept. for right top half shaping on left edge instead of right edge.

TO MAKE UP

Press both pieces. Join centre seam 1st in from each edge matching up pattern (matress st. is recommended for this). Sew seam at bottom corners as shown on chart. Join ends of edging.





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babies lacy dress

Materials

4, 20g balls of Sidar Wonderland Courtelle 3 ply. 4 small buttons. 1 yd. narrow ribbon. No. 10 crochet hook.

Measurements

16 (18) in. chest.

Sleeve seam 2(2) ins.

Back length 15 (16) ins.

Tension

 $7\frac{1}{2}$ sts x 12 row = 1 inch over st.st. T.D. approx 4.



Step 1. C.O.B.H. 99 (111) sts. (odd

needle at left edge of bed) T5 knit 9 rows, trans. every alt. st. to left T5 knit 10 rows. Turn hem.

Step 2.Knit 3 rows st.st. Set m/c for lace pattern, keep 2 sts at each end in st.st. Knit 5 (6) repts of lace pattern Knit 6 rows st.st. Place on waste yarn. Knit another piece to match.

YOKE FRONT

Step 1. With right side of work facing m/c replace sts. from one half of skirt onto 62 (70) sts. by hanging 1 st onto first 5 needles then * 2 sts onto next 2 needles, 1 st. into next needle * repeat from *to* to last five needles hang 1 st onto each needle. T4 knit 1 row, make row of holes by trans. very 3rd st. to adj. needle. Knit 7 (9) rows.





Step 2. Armhole shaping Cast off 3 (4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st at both end of every alt. row 12 (13) times; 32 (36) sts.

Step 3. Place centre 12 (13) sts onto waste yarn. Place sts on left into H.P. Working on right half only, continue dec 1 st at armhole edge every alt. row at the same time dec 1 st at neck edge every alt row 4 times. Continue shaping armhole edge until 2 sts remain, fasten off. Work left side to match, reversing all shaping.



YOKE BACK

Rehang skirt as for front yolk. Knit as for step 1 of front yolk.

Step 2. Starting from the 3rd needle to the left of centre 0 place all sts. to the left on waste yarn and continue on right half only.

Armhole shaping Cast off 3 (4) sts at begin of next row, knit 1 row. Dec. 1 st at beg of next and every alt row 19 (20) times 12 (14) sts. Place sts. on waste yarn. Return needles from left half to m/c cast on 4 sts at right edge for underlap. Knit as for right half reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES

Step 1. C.O.B.H. 55 (61) sts having

extra sts. to left of bed. T5 knit 2 row. Set m/c for pattern and work 1 rept. of lace pattern.

Step 2. Cast off 3 (4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Cont. to knit lace pattern at the same time dec 1 st at both ends of every alt. row 17 (18) times. Place rem. 15 (17) sts on waste yarn.

Sleevebands C.O.B.H. 36 (38) sts. * T4 Knit 5 rows. trans. every alt st. to left T3 knit 6 rows. Turn hem. * With right side of work facing m/c place bottom edge of sleeve onto these sts. gathering as for skirt. Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

Press all pieces. Join raglan seams. NECKBAND

C.O.B.H. 68 (74) sts. Knit as for sleeveband from * to * With right

side of work facing m/c place neck edge evenly onto these sts. Cast off loosely. Work 1 row of double crochet around back opening making 4 small loops for buttons evenly spaced up back opening.

Join side and sleeve seams. Press all seams. Sew of buttons and thread through the ribbon.

pattern variation

Materials

(4) 20g balls Sidar Wonderland 3ply Courtelle. 3 small buttons. No.10 crochet hook.

Measurements

Chest 16 (18) ins.

Sleeve seam 11/2 ins.

Back Length 141/2 (151/2) ins.

Tensions

 $7\frac{1}{2}$ st. x 12 rows = 1 inch over st.st. T.D. aprox 4.

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BACK

Step 1. C.O.B.H. 108 (132) sts. T4 knit 10 rows. T10 Knit 1 row. T5 Knit 10 rows. Turn hem. Knit 2 rows set m/c for lace patt. 000.

Step 2. Keeping 2 sts. at each edge plain. knit to row 96 (104)* Kit 2 rows st.st. Place piece on waste yarn.



Step 3. Rehang skirt onto 61 (73) needles (**method** Place 1st onto first 7 needles, 2st onto every needle to the last 7 needles, 1st to each rem. needle) remove waste yarn. T4 knit 4 (8) rows in st.st. 000.

Step 4. Cast off 3 (4) sts at beg. of next 2 rows. Starting 3rd needle to left of centre 0. place sts. to left on waste yarn and cont. on right half only. Dec. 1 st. at beg of next and every alt rows 3 times. Knit to row 32 (36). C.O.R.



Step 5. Cast off 4 (5) sts at beg on next and every alt. row 3 times. Place rem. sts. on waste yarn Return sts. from left back to m/c and cast on 4 sts. to the right for underlap, Knit as for right half reversing all shaping.

FRONT

Knit as for back to * of step 2. Leave centre 12 sts on centre 12 needles rehang rem. sts. of skirt by placing 2 sts. onto each needle either side of centre needles 1st on last needle 61 (73) sts.

Step 3. Knit 6 (10) rows keeping 1rpt of lace pattern over centre sts. only. 000.

Step 4. Cast off 3 (4) sts at beg. of

next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at both ends every alt. rows 3 times. Knit to row 24 (26).

Shape neck Place centre 15 (19) sts onto waste yarn and continue on right half only. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge every row 3 times then every alt row 2 times. Knit to row 32 (36).

Step 5. as for back. Ret. sts. from left half to m/c and knit as for right front reversing all shaping.

SLEEVES

Step 1. C.O.B.H. 56 (60) sts. T5 knit 4 rows set m/c for lace pattern. Knit 6 rows.

Step 2. Cast off 2 (3) sts at beg of



next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st at both ends of every row 4 times. Dec. 1 st at both ends of every alt row 20 times 24 (26) sts. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 4 rows cast off rem. sts.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out and press all pieces.

SLEEVEBANDS

C.O.B.H. 36 (38) sts. T4 knit 4 rows. T10 knit 1 row, T3 knit 5 rows, turn hem. With right side of work facing m/c replace sts. from bottom of sleeve onto m/c gathering evenely. Cast off loosely.

NECKBAND

C.O.B.H. 68 (74) sts. Knit as for sleeveband. With right side of work facing m/c place neck edge evenly onto these sts. Cast off loosely.

Join side and sleeve seams, work a row of double crochet around back opening, making three loops evenly spaced on one edge for buttonholes. Press all seams. Sew on buttons.



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
