## double-knit ribbed cardigan

#### Materials

27 (29, 31, 33, 35) balls. Lister Elle or Lee Target Titania, double knitting Courtelle/Bri Nylon. 5 buttons.

#### Measurements


To fit 36 (38, 40, 42, 44) ins. chest. Length from shoulder  $26\frac{3}{4}$  (27,  $27\frac{1}{4}$ ,  $27\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $27\frac{3}{4}$ ) ins.

Sleeve seam 18 (18, 18,  $18\frac{1}{2}$ ,  $18\frac{1}{2}$ ) ins.

#### Tension

With Y. feeder on loosest tension (i.e.—)

7 sts. and 12 rows to 1 in. on T8/7 over rib pattern.



#### BACK

1. Hem In D.K. Cast on 133 (141, 147, 155, 161) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. \* T5/5. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T8/7. K. 6 Rs. rib. Start patt. from graph. C.O.R. 000. \* 2. K. 194 Rs.

3. C/O 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) sts. at beg. next 2 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

4. Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. 5 Rs. 10 times 50 Rs.

**5.** K. 58 (60, 62, 64, 66) Rs. straight. **6.** C/O 6 sts. at beg. next 2 (6, 8, 6, 2) sts. Then cast off 5 (5, 6, 7, 7) sts. at beg. next 8 (4, 2, 4, 8) Rs. C/O.

RIGHT FRONT

1. Hem Cast on 63 (67, 71, 75, 79) sts. as 1 x 1 rib, as \* to \* of back. 2. As for back After 54 Rs start

2. As for back. After 54 Rs. start pocket.


#### POCKET

Starting the 19th N. in from front centre, (right) edge; thread up next 35 sts. and take off machine. With spare yarn, cast onto empty Ns. Place wire-loop weight hangers over these Ns. and hang on weights. (Push Ns. to C pos. for next few Rs.) Cont. to armhole.

**3.** K. 1. C/O 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) sts. K. 1. C.O.R. 000.

4. As for back, making dec. on Lt. edge. At the same time after 25 Rs. start Front Neck decs.





#### FRONT NECK

With contrast Y. mark edge st. on centre. Dec. this st. 6 (9, 17, 20, 24) times. Work step **5** as for back.

**6. Shoulder** K. 1. C/O 6 sts. on Lt. edge ev. alt. R. 1 (3, 4, 3, 1) times. Then 5 (6, 6, 7, 7) sts. ev. alt. R. 4 (2, 1, 2, 4) times C/O.

#### **LEFT FRONT**

As for right reversing all shapings.

SLEEVE (knit 2)

1. Hem Cast on 59 (63, 67, 71, 75)

sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T5/5. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T8/7. K. 12 Rs. Rib. Start patt. from graph. C.O.R. 000.

**2.** Inc. 1 st. on each edge ev. 11 Rs. 17 times K. to 198 (198, 198, 204, 204) Rs.

**3.** C/O 8 (9, 9, 10, 10) sts. at beg. next 2 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

**4.** Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. 5 Rs. 11 (12, 10, 8, 6) times. Then ev. 4 Rs. 0 (0, 3, 6, 9) times. K. to 60 (62, 64, 66, 68) Rs.

#### 27 27-29-29-31 STS 55 55-57-57-59 STS 6 61 -61 -63 -7 ins 8 9-9-/10-10 STS 000 3 131, [14-141,-15-151] ins 93 97-101-105-109 STS 18 18-18-18',-18', ins (2) 8 , 9-9 -10-10 ins 59 63-67-71-75 STS

5. C/O 2 sts. at beg. next R. 14 times. C/O rem. sts. Press all pieces. Join shoulders. Sew tops of sleeves into armholes. Join side and sleeve seams.

**POCKET RIBS** 


Cast on 37 sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T5/5. K. 4 Rs. tub. T8/7. K. 6 Rs. rib. Trans. Ns. to M.B. with Rt. side of work facing machine and starting 1 st. in from each edge, place thread-up pocket sts. onto rib. C/O. Repeat.

**POCKET LININGS** 

Cast on 35 sts. in st.st. T8. K. 44 Rs. With Rt. side of work facing machine. place cast-on pocket sts. onto Ns. and C/O. Repeat. On right side of work st. down ribs. On inside of work st. down linings.

#### **FRONT BAND**

C/O 16 sts. as 1 x 1 rib. TO/O. K. 4 Rs. tub. T3/2. K. 4 Rs. rib. H.C.L.'s II. \* Push Lt. 8 sts. to E pos. (on both beds). K. 8 Rs. Break off Y. Push Lt. 8 sts. to C pos. Push Rt. 8 sts. to E pos. Thread Y. between groups of Ns. K. 8 Rs. Break off Y. Push Rt. Ns. to C pos. K 34 Rs. \* Repeat from \* to \* making 5 buttonholes in all. K. until band is long enough to fit (stretching slightly) up both fronts and across back neck. C/O. Pin buttonhole band onto Lt. front with last hole next to marked st. St. in place. Cont. round B.N. and down Ft. front. Press all seams, pockets and band. Sew on buttons to correspond with holes.



## cable dress



Materials

21 (23, 25) ozs. Lee Target Motoravia 4 plv. 18 ins. zip. Buckle.


Measurements

To fit 38 (40, 42) ins. bust. To fit 40 (42, 44) ins. hip.

Length from top of neck to hem  $40\frac{1}{2}$  (41 $\frac{1}{4}$ ).

Tension

7 sts. and 9\frac{1}{2} rows to 1 in. T7.




SKIRT PANEL

1. C.O.B.H. 100 (103, 106) sts. T5. K. 9. T7. K. 1. T5. K. 9. M.D.E. T7. K. 1 row. C.O.R. 000. \* Trans. the 43rd N. in from right edge to the right. Trans. the 51st (54th, 57th) Ns. in from left edge to the left.

\* Repeat trans. every alt. row.

2. H.C.L. II push 36 Ns. to E pos. at opp. end to carr. K. 1 row. Taking yarn round inside N., on next 4 every alt. row. K. 8 rows. Push 9 Ns. back to B at opp. end to carr. on next and every alt. row 4 times. \* Row 6 make cable by trans. 3 Ns. to right between trans., and replacing 3 right Ns. in left empty Ns. \* Repeat cable after every 12 rows. C.O.R. 000.

3. Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 9th row, 21 times to 58 (61, 64) sts. Lengthen or shorten here. K. to 202 (208, 214) rows. Dec. 1 st. on right edge. Thread up sts. and take off M/c. Repeat panel as above once more. For right panels. Repeat 2 panels reversing shapings at steps 1 and 2.



FRONT BODICE

Place sts. of left panel to 57 (60, 63) sts. to left of centre M/c. Place sts. of right panel to right of centre. 114 (120, 126) sts. in all. \* Trans. the 4th N. from centre of M/c. to left. Trans. the 4th N. from centre of M/c. to right. \* Repeat trans. every alt. row. Continue trans. and cables as on skirt panels. C.O.R. 000.

4. Inc. 1 st. on each edge every 5th row 13 times. Row 66 \* H.C.L's II push 40 (40, 42) Ns. to E pos. K. 1. Always taking yarn round inside N. on next and every row. Push 40 (40, 42) Ns. to E pos. K. I. Push back 10 (8, 7) on next 8 (10, 12) rows. \* C.O.R. 066. K. to 76 rows 140 (146, 152) rows

5. Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts. at beg. next 2 rows to 128 (132, 136) sts. C.O.R. 000.

6. Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 3rd row 10 times, then dec. 1 st. on each edge every 2nd row 30 (31, 32) times. Start front neck row 18. Thread up sts. to left of centre and take off M/c. Dec. 1 st. on right neck and every foll. 4th row, 3 times, then dec. 1 st. every 3rd row 20 (21, 22) times. K. to 92 (94, 96) rows. Place left sts. back onto M/c. and repeat front neck step 6 reversing

BACK BODICE

Place left and right panel onto M/c. as for front bodice omitting centre cable pattern.

4. As for front bodice to row 10. Zip opening. Thread up sts. to left of centre and take off M/c. Inc. 1 st. on left of remaining sts. Continue steps 4 and 5 as for front bodice (omitting \*).

6. Shape raglan as for front (omitting neck shaping). K. to 92 (94, 96) rows 25 (26, 27) sts. Thread up back neck sts. and take off M/c. Replace thread up sts. and continue as

above reversing shapings.

**2.** Inc. 1 st. on each edge every 8 (7, 6)

rows 18 (20, 22) times to 94 (98, 102) sts. K. to 148 rows.

3. Cast off 6 (7, 8) sts. at beg. next 2 rows to 82 (84, 86) sts. C.O.R. 000.

4. Dec. 1 st. on each edge every 3rd row 16 (18, 20) times. Then dec. 1 st. on each edge every 2nd row 18 (16, 14) times to 14 (16, 18) sts. K. to 86 (88, 90) rows. Cast off. Repeat sleeve. Press back, front and sleeves. Join sleeve and bodice raglans, with centre of sleeve head meeting top of bodice. Join centre panels of skirt. Press all seams.

NECKBAND

C.O.B.H. 74 (77, 80) sts. T5. K. 12 rows. Dec. 1 st. every alt. row on right edge 6 times. T7. K. 1 row. T5. K. 12 rows. Inc. 1 st. every alt. row 6 times. M.D.E. Place  $\frac{1}{2}$  back neck to first 24 (25, 26) sts. Place  $\frac{1}{2}$  front neck to 50 (52, 54) sts. and cast off. Repeat neckband, reversing mitred edge. Finish off mitre, press band.

RIGHT COLLAR

C.O.B.H. 57 (61, 64) sts. T7. K. 19 rows. C.O.L. Push 32 Ns. to E pos. at opp. end to carr. H.C.L's II. K. 1 always taking yarn round inside N. on next and every alt. row K. I row. Push 8 Ns. back to B pos. on next 8 rows. T8. K. 1 row. T7. K. 1 row. C.O.L. Working from right edge trans. the 3rd N. to right. \* Miss next 6 Ns. trans. next N. to left. Miss next 3 Ns., trans. next N. to right. \* Repeat trans. to end of collar. Push 32 Ns. at opp. end to carriage. to E pos. H.C.L's II. K. 2. Push 8 Ns. back to B pos. on next 8 rows. \* Trans. 3 Ns. between trans. to right and replace 3 Ns. in left empty Ns. \* Repeat after next 12 rows. K. to row 57. C.O.L. T5. K. 6 rows. Inc. 1 st. on right edge every alt. row 3 times. T7. K. 1 row. T5. K. 6 rows. Dec. 1 st. every alt. row 3 times. M.D.E. Cast off. Press collar. Fold in half and st. along top of hem.

**COLLAR BAND** 

C.O.B.H. 18 sts. T5. K. 6. Inc. 1 st. on left edge every alt. row. T7. K. 1. T5. K. 6. Dec. 1 st. on left, every alt. row. M.D.E. Place longest edge of collar onto Ns. Working through both layers. Cast off. Join mitre. Press collar.

LEFT COLLAR

C.O.B.H. 57 (61, 64) sts. T7. K. 20 rows. C.O.R. Continue shapings as for right collar, reversing shapings. Make trans. as for right collar, working from left edge. Continue reversing shapings. K. to row 57. Make hem as before reversing mitre edge. Cast off. Make collar band as above, reversing mitred edge. Press collar.

TO MAKE UP

Starting  $1\frac{1}{4}$  ins. approx. from front mitre, sew top of collar to edges of neckbands, ending at back neck openings. Join side and sleeve seams. Crochet down zip opening. Insert zip. Press seams, crocheting and collar seam. On front and back corner tips of collar, secure in place by stitching onto bodice.

BELT

C.O.B.H. 200 (110, 116) sts. T5. K. 5. T7. K. 1. T5. K. 9. T7. K. 1. T5. K. 5. M.D.E. Cast off. For last 2 sizes repeat belt and join seam. Fold along loose rows and st. 2 seams. St. to buckle. Press.

FOR BELT LOOPS

Cast on 1 N. T2 with one p.b. in. K. a few rows. Repeat.

Knitted to fit size 34 ins. bust. Zipped jacket featuring weave patt. front, with fabric used side-on. Worn with weave patt. skirt and hat.

#### STYLE B

Knitted to fit size 28 ins. bust. Zipped iacket with saddle-shouldered sleeves and weave patt. bodice. Worn with weave patt, trousers and

Hat Style B 1 ball of 4 ply. Colour A. 1 ball of D.K. Colour A. Small ball each of colours B, C and D in D.K. Yarns By Robin—Vogue 4 ply and

Vogue Double-Knitting.

To fit 28 (30, 32, 34, 36) ins. bust. Length of jacket from shoulder 1834  $(19, 19\frac{3}{4}, 20, 20\frac{3}{4})$  ins. Inside sleeve measurement 141  $(15\frac{1}{2}, 16\frac{1}{2}, 17, 17\frac{1}{2})$  ins. Trousers. Inside leg measurement 24  $(26\frac{1}{2}, 29, 31, 33)$  ins. Skirt. Waist measurement 24 (25, 26, 27, 28) ins. Length from waist  $17\frac{1}{2}$  (19,  $20\frac{1}{2}$ , 22, Hat. To fit small (medium, larger).

K. 18 Rs. T9. K. 1. T7. K. 18 Rs. M.D.E. Unravel W. WI.\*. Dec. or inc. 1 st. on Lt. edge to 91 (97, 103, 109, 115) sts. C.O.R. In colour A. 4 ply. T6. (Set M/c. to weave patt. 1 on 810 M/cs.) K. 1. C.O.L. 000. Start weave patt. 1 using colour A. D.K.

Step 2. T8. K. 85 (85, 89, 89, 93) Rs. straight.

Step 3. C/O. 4 (5, 6, 6, 7) sts. at beg. next 2 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

Step 5. K. 36 (38, 40, 42, 44) Rs. straight. C.O.R. 000.



K. 1 T7. K. 22 Rs. M.D.E. Unravel W. Wl. Dec. or Inc. 1 st. on edge to 41 (45, 45, 49, 49) sts. C.O.R. In colour A. 4 ply. T6.

(Set M/c. to weave patt. 1 on 810 M/cs.) K. 1. C.O.L. 000. Start weave





They are the largest manufacturers of domestic knitting machines in the world making and selling between 400,000 and 500,000 units per year. The majority of this phenomenal total is still sold in Japan and only a very small percentage is sold on the world market. We in Jones are one of their major customers and sell four models. This is unlike the Japanese market where they always concentrate on the very latest machine and discontinue earlier models the minute a new model arrives. Obviously the approach differs with the market.


Since the early 1960's Brother has been at the forefront of knitting machine development and came out with a world beater, the model 585 (later modified to the model 588) which has a lace carriage which automatically transfers stitches thus enabling even a beginner to do complex operations involving knitting two

properly. When knitting Fair Isle the two colours are fed through the wool feed together making Fair Isle patterns as easy to knit as plain stocking stitch. This is a great time-saver and greatly increases the neatness of the finished effect when working in two colours. The punch-cards, whether it is a pre-punched card or one of the cards you can punch yourself, takes care of the pattern automatically, all you do is push the carriage. There is nothing to remember. If you require a single motif or column of pattern you can push back needles where you do not require the pattern and it will only appear on the remaining needles. This is the single motif work which has been possible on the Jones machines for almost 10 years, a long way ahead of our rivals who have only just come up with a simple method. Another fantastic feature with this machine is the way Brother have automated the lace carriage so that even a beginner can knit lace patterns without constant reference to charts. The pattern repeat is over 24 needles and very complex lace patterns can be worked out. Remember this is a proper

over 24 needles automatically; knit weaving patterns over 24 stitches; easily weave more than two colours in one row.

We are sure this machine will be a world beater. Already even without advertising or announcing its arrival we have sold a considerable number, purely by rumour. This is almost unheard of in previous instances and we look forward to a fantastic boom in sales as the knitting public gets to know about the Jones Knit-O-Matic. For one or two of our customers who have earlier models and wish to partexchange, we can arrange this through local agents, but bear the following in mind. As a company we do not market machines and constantly bring out new models in the hopes that old customers will part-exchange. When we bring a machine on to the market we are sure that it is the best value at its price at that particular time and if your old machine does sufficient for you, please do not be tempted by sales talk into partexchanging for a new machine.

It is always nice to have the latest but on the other hand if you do not require pat-



stitches together and making one. These two machines founded the name for reliability and good workmanship which the Brother products have today.

With the market the size of their home market they cannot afford to make mistakes in terms of construction or design as this would be disastrous when you consider the number of machines they sell in Japan. We have the advantage in England of buying the machines after they have been tested on the Japanese market so that 9 times out of 10 all the teething troubles are removed before we receive the machine. This has meant that knitting machines in England have not suffered any serious setbacks from bad design and production in the last 10 years.

Jones are very proud to be able to present the latest in a line of successful machines which we are going to call the Jones Knit-O-Matic (code number 820). This is the best knitting machine available today. After several years of careful research Brother have found the simplest and safest way to produce wonderful knitting for either stocking stitch or fancy patterns. We think the average housewife will be able to knit complex Fair Isle patterns after only a few hours practice, in fact in a matter of minutes if shown

hand knitting stitch to give a genuine knitting of two stitches together and making one and not an attempt to achieve something which looks like it by using invisible thread. It is so much nicer to have baby garments which are soft to the touch and do not have nylon threads in which the baby can catch its fingers.

For quite some time our machines have been able to weave patterns and we have now increased the scope by having the patterns over 24 needles instead of the smaller numbers on earlier models. A big plus to bear in mind with the Jones machine is that many different colours can be woven in one row. For instance if you wish to weave three different colours in one row this is very easy and some striking effects can be obtained. Super textures and colour ways can be achieved in a fabric which in many instances can be treated as an ordinary woven fabric, i.e., it can be cut and sewn.

If you combine the weaving with the lace a whole new range of patterns can be obtained again over 24 needles giving patterns which can only be done on this machine. Some others can do it, but over a very much smaller pattern repeat. So remember the Knit-O-Matic is the only punch-card machine which will knit 'knit two together and make one' patterns

terns over 24 stitches and the other items mentioned in the previous paragraphs, you would merely be losing money in making an exchange. We continue to stock spares for all the models we have sold and will continue to do so in the future. Stitchin' time will continue to be produced with patterns for all the different models, although the pictures illustrated may be for the new model only, but with a little working out they can be knitted on the other machines as well.

Should you decide to part-exchange, the following facts must be borne in mind. The only attachments which fit this machine (the Knit-O-Matic) is the ribbing attachment KR810 and the knitleader attachment KL115. The KL115 will not be here in this country until some time in the New Year. Earlier model ribbing attachments and knitleaders cannot be adapted. We are sorry this has to happen, but unfortunately due to the completely new system used in the Knit-O-Matic an adaptor cannot be made. These two new attachments however, fit the earlier models. By the time this is published we should have available blank cards, pre-punched cards, puncher sets and stitch pattern books, i.e., similar to the cassette book for the model 800, available for this machine.

#### TO MAKE UP SCARF

Press on the wrong side with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join row ends of scarf on the wrong side, turn right side out, then neatly over-sew each end.

#### FRINGE

Cut 4 strands of C each 7 ins. long, fold in half and knot through end of scarf. Make 8 more tassells in the

same way and knot at equal distances apart. Work along opposite end of scarf to match. With small flower loom make 8 daisies using C and st. 4 to each end of scarf, 2 on either side.

Step 6. H.P. \* Push 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) Ns. to E pos. at opp. end to carr. on next 6 Rs. Then 5 (4, 6, 5, 7) Ns. to E pos. on next 2 Rs. Return Ns. on Lt. to C pos. K. 1. Return Ns. on Rt. to C pos. K. 1. Thread-up back neck sts. and take off. C/O shoulders.

#### **FRONT**

As for back to step 4.

**Step 4.** H.P. Push Ns. to Lt. of centre to E pos. At the same time as working armhole as for back, on front neck dec. 1 st. at 000 then ev. 4 Rs. 15 times. Then ev. 3 Rs. 10 (11, 12, 13, 14) times.

**Step 6.** K. 1. C.O.L. H.P. \* Push 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) Ns. to E pos. on Rt. edge ev. alt. R. 3 times. Then 5 (4, 6, 5, 7) Ns. to E pos. once. Return Ns. on Rt. to C pos. K. 1. C/O. Return Ns. on Lt. to B pos. and set for jacq. Work front neck and armhole as before, reversing **all** shapings.

**Step 6.** C.O.R. H.P. \* Push 4 (5, 5, 6, 6) Ns. to E pos. on Lt. edge ev. alt. R. 3 times. Then 5 (4, 6, 5, 7) Ns. to E pos. once. Return Ns. to C pos. K. 1. C/O.

#### TO MAKE UP

Press. Join shoulders.

#### ARMBANDS

**Ribbers** In colour A. Cast on 119 (123, 127, 131, 135) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. TO/O. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. Inc. 1 st. on each edge ev. alt. R. 7 times. Trans. Ns. to M.B.

Single bed M/cs. With W. Wl. Cast onto 133 (137, 141, 145, 149) sts. K. a few Rs. Change to colour A. T5. Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. alt. R. 8 times. T7. K. 1. T5. Inc. 1 st. on each edge ev. alt. R. 8 times. (17 Rs. in all.) M.D.E. Unravel W. Wl. With Rt. side of work facing M/c., place armhole evenly onto Ns. and C/O in colour B.

#### **NECKBAND**

**Ribbers** In colour A. Cast on 156 (162, 168, 174, 180) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. TO/O. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. Inc. 1 st. on each edge ev. alt. R. 9 times. Trans. Ns. to M.B.

Single bed M/cs. With W. Wl. Cast onto 174 (180, 186, 192, 198) sts. K. a few Rs. Change to colour A. T5. Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. alt. R. 10 times. T7. K. 1. T5. Inc. 1 st. on each edge ev. alt. R. 10 times. (21 Rs. in all.) M.D.E. Unravel W. Wl. With Rt. side of work facing M/c. Place side neck to 61 (63, 65, 67, 69) Ns. Back neck to 52 (54, 56, 58, 60) Ns. C/O in colour B up to this point. Place side neck to rest of Ns. and C/O to end. Join neckband mitre. Join side seams and armband mitres. Press all seams and bands.





**Step 2.** Start patt. (M. Wl. in main feeder, C. Wl. in jacq. feeder). T9. K. 104 Rs. straight.

**Step 3.** C/O 9 (10, 11) sts. at beg. next 2 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

**Step 4.** Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. 3 Rs. 10 times to 30 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

**Step 5.** K. 36 (38, 40) Rs. straight. C.O.R. 000.

Step 6. H.P. \* Push 7 Ns. to E pos. at opp. end to carr. on next 4 Rs. Then 6 (7, 8) Ns. to E pos. on next 4 Rs. Return Ns. on Lt. to C pos. K. 1. Return Ns. on Rt. to C pos. K. 1. C/O to end.

RIGHT FRONT

Start the 13th N. to Rt. of centre.

**Step 1.** Cast on 63 (67, 71) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. K. as \* to \* of back.

Step 2. As for back to 94 Rs. Mark Lt. edge st. with C. Wl. Dec. this st. Then dec. 1 st. on Lt. edge ev. 4 Rs. 7 (10, 13) times. Then ev. 5 Rs. 10 (8, 6) times.

At the same time After 104 Rs.

**Step 3.** On Rt. edge C/O 9 (10, 11) sts. K. 2 Rs. C.O.R. 000.


**Step 4.** Dec. 1 st. on Rt. edge ev. 3 Rs. 10 times. C.O.R. 000.

Step 5. K. 36 (38, 40) Rs. C.O.R. 000.

Step 6. K. 1. C.O.L. H.P. \* Push 7 Ns. to E pos. on Rt. edge ev. alt. R. twice. Then 6 (7, 8) Ns. to E pos. twice. Return Ns. to C pos. K. 1. C/O.

LEFT FRONT

Start the 12th N. to Lt. of centre. K. as for right front, reversing all shapings.



#### **SLEEVES**

**Step 1.** Cast on 61 (65, 69) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. in C. WI. (extra st. on Rt.). TO/O. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. K. 43 Rs. rib. Trans. Ns. to M.B. C.O.L.  $T7\frac{2}{3}$ . Set for jacq. R. 42. K. 1. R. plain. C.O.R. 000.

Step 2. Start patt. T9. Inc. 1 st. on each edge ev. 6 Rs. 10 times. Then ev. 7 Rs. 8 times. K. to 122 Rs.

Step 3. As for back.

**Step 4.** Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. 3 Rs. 14 times. To 42 Rs. C.O.R. 000.


Step 5. H.P. \* Push 4 Ns. to E pos. at opp. end to carr. on next 4 Rs. Then push 3 Ns. to E pos. on next 4 Rs. Return Ns. on Lt. to C pos. K. 1. Return Ns. on Rt. to C pos. K. 1. C/O to end. Repeat.

TO MAKE UP

Press all pieces. Join shoulders. Sew tops of sleeves into armholes. Press seams. Join side and sleeve seams.

FRONT BAND

With M. Wl. Cast on 20 sts. as allneedle rib, (i.e. 10 sts. on M.B. 10 sts. on rib. B. T0/0. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. K. 2 Rs. rib. \* H.P. Push 10 Ns. to E pos. on Lt. K. 11 Rs. C.O.L. Push all Ns. to E pos. Move carr. to Rt. side. Return 10 Ns. on Lt. to C pos. Break off Y. and thread ends between sets of Ns. K. 11 Rs. C.O.L. Push Ns. on Rt. to C pos. K. 27 Rs \*. Repeat from \* to \* making 5 buttonholes in all. K. straight until long enough to fit up both fronts and across B.N. (stretching slightly). C/O. Pin band to front edge with top buttonhole level with marked st. on Rt. front. Press all seams and band. Sew on buttons to correspond with holes.



#### VEST TOP-BACK

Step 1. \* In M. WI. Cast on 119 (127, 135) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. (extra st. on Lt.). TO/O. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. K. 29 Rs. rib. Trans. Ns. to M.B. T7\frac{2}{3}. \* K. 1. C.O.R. 000.

Step 2. K. 90 Rs. straight.

**Step 3.** C/O 10 (11, 12) sts. at beg. next 2 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

**Step 4.** Dec. 1 st. on each edge ev. 3 Rs. 10 times. To 30 Rs. C.O.R. 000.

**Step 5.** K. 52 (54, 56) Rs. straight. C.O.R. 000.

Step 6. H.P. \* Push 5 (6, 7) Ns. to E pos. at opp. end to carr. on next 4 Rs. Then 5 Ns. to E pos. on next 4 Rs. Return Ns. on Lt. to C pos. K. 1.



Return Ns. on Rt. to C pos. K. 1. C/O shoulders and back neck sts. and take off M/c.

#### FRONT

= M.wl

**Step 1.** K. as back \* to \*. C.O.L. Set M/c. for jacq. K. 1. C.O.R. 000.

Step 2. (See instructions for One-Point pattern knitting in punch-card book). Except for 1st pattern group of Ns. to Lt. of centre, push all other Ns. back to B pos. by hand. Do this for ev. R. until one repeat of patt. has been knitted. Except for group of Ns. at centre of M/c., push all other Ns. to B pos. for 1 repeat of patt. Except for 1st patt. group of Ns. to Rt. of centre push all other Ns. to B pos. for 1 repeat of patt. At the same time work steps 2 and 3 as for back.

Step 4. Work as for back. After 10 Rs. Dec. centre st. to Rt. Thread-up sts. to Lt. of centre and take off M/c. Cont. working Rt. armhole as for back.

**At the same time** On Lt. edge dec. 1 st. ev. 3 Rs. 4 (6, 8) times. Then ev. 4 Rs. 15 (14, 13) times.

Step 5. K. 1. C.O.L. H.P. \* Push 5 (6, 7) Ns. to E pos. on Rt. edge ev. alt. R. twice, then 5 Ns. to E pos. ev. alt. R.

twice. Return Ns. to C pos. K. 1. C/O. Return Lt. Ns. to M/C., 1 st. to Lt. of centre. K. as for Rt. neck reversing **all** shapings.

**Step 6.** Push 5 (6, 7) Ns. to E pos. on Lt. edge ev. alt. R. twice. Then 5 Ns. to E pos. twice. Return to C pos. K. 1. C/O.

#### TO MAKE UP

Press pieces. With right side of front uppermost pin-out to shape. With tacking thread tack one diagonal line across bottoms of motifs, and one across tops of motifs. With C. WI., work a line of chain-st. along the tacking thread. Remove thread. Join shoulders.

#### **ARMBANDS**

In C. WI., cast on 135 (139, 143) sts. as 1  $\times$  1 rib. T0/0. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. K. 10 Rs. rib. Trans. Ns. to M.B. With Rt. side of work facing M/c., place armhole evenly onto N/s. and C/O in M. WI.

#### COLLAR

In C. WI., cast on 143 (149, 155) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T0/0. K. 4 Rs. Tub. T3/3. K. 50 Rs. straight.

#### **VEST TOP**

On Lt. edge push 54 Ns. to E pos. C/O 35 (41, 47) sts. at centre. C.O.R. H.P. \* Push 4 Ns. to E pos. on Lt. edge ev. alt. R. 13 times. Return Ns. to C pos. K. 1. C/O. C.O.R. Return Ns. on Lt. to C pos. K. 1. Push 4 Ns. to E pos. ev. alt. R. 13 times on Rt. edge. Return Ns. to C pos. K. 1. C/O. Press collar lightly. Pin collar in pos. around neck and sl.st. in place. St. collar tog. at front for  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. approx. Join side seams. Press all seams.


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
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
