

In recent months there has been a growing demand for people who can use the model 588 or the model 800 sufficiently well to knit fashion garments and we are proposing to prepare an index of people who are prepared to knit to make money and a corresponding index of companies and individuals who require knitters. If you wish to go on this index, please let us know the model machine you have, your name and address in block capitals and your telephone number if any and how much work per week you are prepared to do. We cannot in any way guarantee that work will be given, however, with knitwear being high fashion as it is and a large number of small designers setting up on their own, we are sure for anyone who can produce quality knitwear there will be a steady flow of work.

In our fashion format section you will notice that we have included a set of 6 designs all of which are based on the same basic shape but the neck lines and sleeve shapes vary. We hope these patterns are liked and are not too complex for you to follow. In response to demands for slightly more fashionable garments in the magazine (we are not going to get too trendy), we are thinking of taking on two young designers and their patterns will be printed in the new form i.e. with the bare minimum of instructions and mainly diagrams.

Although most of the patterns are adapted to both machines, occasionally a designer who does not know the conversion, writes patterns merely for either the model 800 or the earlier models and therefore if this occurs, please check with the chart below to find the correct settings for your H.C.L's.

800 H.C.L. 3 = I for all others

800 H.C.L. 1 = II for all others

800 H.C.L. 2 = III for all others.

N.B. CHARTS SUBMITTED BY DESIGNERS VARY DEPENDING ON WHICH MACHINE THE DESIGNER HAS USED. MOST PATTERNS USING EIGHT BUTTONS CAN BE DONE ON EITHER THE 588 OR THE 585. THE DIFFERENCES ARE

cable sweater

Materials

14 (15, 16, 17) ozs. Emu Scotch 4 ply wool.

Measurements

To fit bust sizes 32 (34, 36, 38) ins. Length to shoulder $23\frac{1}{4}$ ($23\frac{1}{2}$, $23\frac{3}{4}$, 24) ins. Sleeve seam $17\frac{1}{7}$ ins.

Tension

T6. 15\frac{1}{2} sts. and 21 rows to 2 ins. over st.st.

Abbreviations

K., knit; sts., stitches; inc., increase; dec., decrease; alt., alternate; foll., following; beg., beginning; rem., remain; M.B., main bed; H.C.L's., holding cam levers; T., tension; 000., set row counter at 000.

Cable pattern

K. 8 rows. Cross sts. 1, 2 and 3 over 4, 5 and 6.

Notes

When dec. and shaping count needles in A position as one st.

BACK

Ribbers Cast on 131 (139, 147, 155) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T3/3. K. 20 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool, cast on 66 (70, 74, 78) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to main wool. T4. K. 39 rows. Make a hem and K. the row. *

All machines 000. T6. K. straight to 152 rows. Adjust length here if required.

Shape Armhole

000. Cast off 5 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next 5 (7, 7, 9) rows then every alt. row 5 (4, 5, 4) times. 101 (107, 113, 119) sts. rem. * *. K. straight to 72 (74, 76, 78) rows.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 6 (6, 7, 7) sts. at beg. of next 8 rows, and 6 (8, 6, 8) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Slip rem. 41 (43, 45, 47) sts. on to a knitting needle.

FRONT

K. as back to *. Arrange needles for cables. Counting from the centre transfer the 2nd and foll. 7th st. (both sides) on to adjacent needles. Counting from each side transfer the 23rd (24th, 25th, 26th) st. and foll. 7th, 10th and 17th st. on to adjacent needles. Push empty needles to A position. Foll. cable pattern K. as back to * *. K. straight to 48 (50, 52, 54) rows.

Shape Neck

Cast off centre 21 (23, 25, 27) sts. Push needles at left to E position. H.C.L's III. K. right side first. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next 5 rows, and foll. alt. rows 5 times. 30 (32, 34, 36) sts. rem. K. straight to 72 (74, 76, 78) rows.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 6 (6, 7, 7) sts. at beg. of next and foll. alt. row 4 times in all. K. 1 row. Cast off rem. 6 (8, 6, 8) sts. H.C.L's I. K. left side to match reversing all shapings.

SLEEVES

Ribbers Cast on 61 (65, 69, 73) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T3/3. K. 20 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 31 (33, 35, 37) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to main wool. T4. K. 39 rows. Make a hem and K. the row.

All machines Arrange needles for centre cable panel as on Front. 000. T6. K. 8 rows.



mans t-shirt

Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and every foll. 9th row 16 times in all. 93 (97, 101, 105) sts. K. straight to 162 rows. (Adjust length here if required.)

Shape Top

000. Cast off 5 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next 3 (5, 5, 5) rows then foll. alt. row 5 (4, 4, 4) times. K. 3 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 4th row 3 times in all, then every alt. row 4 (5, 6, 6) times. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next 7 (7, 5, 7) rows. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 6 (6, 8, 8) rows. Cast off rem. 21 sts.


NECKBAND With wrong side facing and beg. at right, place on machine 41 (43, 45, 47) sts. from back neck, pick up 30 sts. down front neck, 21 (23, 25, 27) sts. from centre and 30 sts. up front neck. 122 (126, 130, 134) sts. T6. K. 1 row.

Ribbers Transfer alt. sts. to ribber. T3/3. K. 20 rows. K. 1 loose row. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B. Cast off chain method.

Single machines Transfer alt. sts. to adjacent needles and push empty needles to A position. T4. K. 20 rows. Bring empty needles to B position. K. 1 loose row and cast off chain method.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out and press with a hot iron over a damp cloth. Join shoulder seams. Sew in sleeves, then join side and sleeve seams. Fold neck band to inside and slip-st. in place. Press seams.





Materials

Striped T. Shirt 7 (8, 9, 10) ozs. Listers Lavenda 4 ply in M. 4 (4, 5, 5) ozs. Listers Lavenda 4 ply in A. 4 (4, 5, 5) ozs. Listers Lavenda 4 ply in B. Allow 1 oz. extra in M. for collar.

Plain T. Shirt 14 (16, 17, 19) ozs. in M. 1 button Crochet Hook. Allow 1 oz. extra for collar.

Measurements

To fit chest sizes 36 (38, 40, 42) ins. Length to back neck 26 $(26\frac{1}{2}, 27, 27\frac{1}{2})$ ins. Sleeve seam $4\frac{1}{2}$ ins.

Tension

T6. 15 sts. and 20 rows to 2 ins.

Abbreviations

K., knit; sts., stitches; dec., decrease; inc., increase; beg., beginning; alt., alternate; foll., following; rem., remain; H.C.L's., holding cam levers; 000., set row counter at 000; T., tension; M.B., main bed.

Notes

For striped garment please knit stripes throughout as follows: M 2 rows. A 2 rows. M 4 rows. B 2 rows. M 2 rows. A 4 rows. M 2 rows. B 2 rows. M 4 rows. A 2 rows. M 2 rows. B 4 rows (32 rows). Fully fashioning at raglan edges is worked by transferring the 4th st. onto 5th needle and moving end sts. 1 needle in.

SHIRT WITH ROUND NECK BACK

Ribbers With M wool cast on 135 (143, 151, 159) sts. for 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 20 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines With waste wool cast on 68 (72, 76, 80) sts. over alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to M. T4. K. 39 rows. Make a hem and K. the row. 135 (143,151, 159) sts.

All machines 000. T6. K. 144 rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 4 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. (see notes) each end of next and foll. 4th rows 5 times in all * Then on every alt. row until 45 (47, 49, 51) sts. rem. K. 1 row. Slip sts. onto a knitting needle. For shirt with collar cast off sts.

FRONT

K. as back to * K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. each end of next and foll. alt. row until 62 (68, 74, 80) rows have been worked.

Shape Neck

Cast off centre 21 (23, 25, 27) sts. Push sts. at left to E pos. H.C.L's III. ** Continue to dec. at raglan as before at the same time dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next and foll. alt. rows 10 times in all. Keep neck edge straight and dec. at raglan edge until 2 sts. rem. Cast off. H.C.L's I. K. to match right side

reversing all shapings.

SLEEVES

Ribbers With M wool cast on 87 (91, 95, 99) sts. for 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 14 rows. Trans. ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines With waste wool cast on 44 (46, 48, 50) sts. over alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to M. T4. K. 27 rows. Make a hem and K. the row. 87 (91, 95, 99) sts.

All machines 000. T6. K. 8 rows. Inc. 1 st. each end of next and foll. 4th row 9 times in all. 105 (109, 113, 117) sts. K. straight to 48 rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 4 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of next and foll. 4th row 6 (7, 8, 9) times in all, then on every foll. alt. row until 17 sts. rem. K. 1 row. Slip sts. onto a knitting needle. For shirt with collar cast off sts.

NECKBAND

With wrong side facing pick up and place on machine 45 (47, 49, 51) sts. from back neck, 17 sts. from 1st. sleeve. 69 (71, 73, 75) sts. from front neck, 17 sts. from 2nd sleeve 148 (152, 156, 160) sts. T6. K. 1 row.

Ribbers Trans. alt. sts. to ribber for 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 20 rows. K. 1 row. T10/8. Trans. ribber sts. to M.B. Cast off chain

method.

Single machines Trans. alt. sts. to adjacent needles. Return empty needles to A. pos. T4. K. 20 rows. Bring needles in A. pos. back to B. pos. T10. K. 1 row. Chain cast

TO MAKE UP

Pin out and press with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join raglan, side and sleeve seams. Turn neckband to inside and slip-st. in place. Press seams.

SHIRT WITH COLLAR **BACK AND SLEEVES**

K. as given for Back and sleeves of round neck shirt.

FRONT

K. as back to * K. 1 row.

Divide For Front Opening

Trans. centre st. to adjacent needle. Push sts. at left to E pos. H.C.L's III. Dec. 1 st. at raglan edge on next and foll, alt, row until 61 (67, 73, 79) rows have been worked. (K. 1 row extra for left side.)

Shape Neck

Cast off 10 (11, 12, 13) sts. at beg. of next row. Work as round neck from ** to end. H.C.L's I. K. to match right side reversing shapings.


COLLAR

000. T4. With M cast on 139 (143, 147, 151) sts. by hand. K. 2 rows. H.C.L's II. Always winding wool round first needle in E pos. * Push 8 (8, 9, 9) needles at opposite end to carriage to E pos. on next 10 rows. Return all needles at opposite end to carriage to C pos. on next 2 rows. * T5. K. 30 rows. T9. K. 1 row. T5. K. 30 rows. T4. K. from * to * K. 2 rows. Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

As round neck. Join narrow ends of collar. Sew shaped edge to neck. Work 1 row of double crochet round neck opening making a loop at neck edge on one side. Sew on button. Press seams.

summer jumper



Materials

6 (7, 7) balls of Jaeger Gaelic Spun in main colour white; one ball in each of the following colours: juniper, clover, cherry, cornelia, cowslip, blackberry, cornflower.

Tension

7 sts. and 10 rows to 1 in.

Abbreviations

K., knit; p., purl; st., stitch; tog., together; dec., decrease; inc., increase; m., main colour.

Measurements

To fit bust sizes 32 (34, 36) ins. All round at underarms 32 (34, 36) ins. Side seam $13\frac{1}{2}$ ($13\frac{1}{2}$, $13\frac{1}{2}$) ins. Length 21 ($21\frac{1}{4}$, $21\frac{1}{2}$) ins. Sleeve seam 17 (17, 17) ins.

Note

The ribbing may also be worked by hand using a pair of No. 13 knitting needles or by using a single bed machine and dropping every 3rd and 4th st. to pick up with the latch tool to turn to K. sts.

BACK

With m. cast on 104 (112, 120) sts. for 2 x 2 rib. Set tension 3 sizes finer than main tension.

Work 40 rows in 2 x 2 rib.

* Continuing in rib work in stripes as follows: 2 rows juniper green, 2 rows cowslip yellow, 2 rows cornelian orange, 2 rows cherry red, 2 rows clover, 2 rows blackberry, 2 rows cornflower blue *.

Transfer sts. to 1 bed. Change to main tension. Set row counter at 000. Continue with m. only.

Work 5 rows straight.

Using the 3 x 3 transfer tool cable 6 sts. at centre of bed and the 31st to 36th sts. each side of centre. Work 5 rows.

The last 10 rows form the pattern; continuing as set inc. 1 st. at each end of the next row and the 3 following 20th rows to 112 (120, 128) sts.

Work 19 rows more to 90 rows on counter

To shape the armholes: cast off 6 sts. at the beginning of the next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of the next row and every alternate row 10 (12, 14) times in all to 80 (84, 88) sts.

Work 47 rows to 158 (162, 166) rows on counter. Drop 2 sts. at each side of cables and pick up with latch tool to form K. st. ridges.

To slope shoulders: cast off 7 sts. at beginning of next 4 rows and 5 (6, 7) sts. on the 2 following rows to 42 (44, 46) sts.

For back neckband: Transfer sts. to 2 beds for 2 x 2 rib. With green rib 1 row, with yellow rib 1 row, with orange rib 1 row, with red rib 1 row, with pink rib 1 row, with blackberry rib 1 row, with blue rib 1 row, with m. rib 2 rows, then cast off loosely.

FRONT

Work as for back to **. Divide sts. for neck: Next row: Slip 56 (60, 64) sts. at left onto a holder and continue on remaining 56 (60, 64) sts. for right front shoulder. The right front shoulder: To shape the armhole and to slope the neck: Cast off 6 sts. at the beginning and dec. 1 st. at end of next row. (1) Work 1 row straight, (2) Dec. at armhole edge on next row, (3) Dec. at neck edge on next row, (4) Dec. at armhole edge on next row, (5) Work 1 row straight, (6) Dec. at each end of next row.

Repeat last 6 rows twice (3 times) (3 times) then work the first 2 (1, 4) rows again. Continuing to dec. at neck edge on every 3rd row, work 40 (38, 38) rows more to 19 (20, 21) sts. and 151 (154, 157) rows on counter. Work 7 (8, 9) rows to 158 (162, 166) rows on counter. Drop 2 sts. at each side of cables, pick up with latch tool to form K., st. ridges.

To slope the shoulders: cast off 7 sts. at beginning of next row and following alternate row. On 5 (6, 7) sts. work 1 row, then cast off.

The left front shoulder: slip sts. from holder back onto 1 bed, rejoin yarn and work to end of row. Reset row counter at 90 and work as for right front shoulder to end.

SLEEVES (both alike)
With m. cast on 56 (60, 64) sts. for 2 x 2 rib. Set tension 3 places finer than main tension. Work 22 rows in 2 x 2 rib. Now work as far back from * to *. Transfer sts. to 1 bed. Change to main tension. Set row counter at 000. Working 6 st. cables at centre on every 10th row as for back continue as follows: Work 4 rows. Inc. 1 st. at each end of next row and every following 10th row 14 times in all to 84 (88, 92) sts.

Work 5 rows to 140 rows on counter. To shape sleevetop: cast off 5 (6, 7) sts. at beginning of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next row and every following 4th row to 16 (17, 18) times in all 42 sts. Drop sts. each side of cable panel and using latch tool pick up sts. to form K. st. ridges. Cast off taking 3 sts. tog. all along the row.

LEFT AND RIGHT FRONT

NECKBANDS (alike)
With right side of work facing loop up 56 (58, 60) sts. from one front edge. Position sts. on 2 beds for 2 x 2 rib. Working in rib in stripe sequence given for back neckband decrease 1 st. at centre front end on each row. Cast off loosely.

TO COMPLETE

Press with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join shoulder seams, continuing across neckband. Set in sleeves. Join sleeve and side seams. Join row ends of neckband at centre front. Press seams.

toddlers outfit

Materials

Sweater

1 (2, 2) ozs. Emu 4 ply wool in colour A. 2 (3, 3) ozs. in colour B. 1 (2, 2) ozs. in colour C. 3 buttons.

Trousers

4 (5, 5) ozs. in colour A. Elastic to fit waist.

Hat

Allow $\frac{1}{2}$ oz. in each colour.

Measurements

Sweater

To fit chest size 18 (20, 22) ins. Finished measurements 20 (22, 24) ins.

Trousers

Inside leg seam $7\frac{1}{2}$ ($8\frac{1}{2}$, $9\frac{1}{2}$) ins.

Hat

To fit average size head.

Tension

T6. $11\frac{1}{3}$ sts. and 31 rows to 2 ins.

Abbreviations

K., knit; sts., stitches; inc., increase; dec., decrease; alt., alternate; foll., following; rem., remain; beg., beginning; H.C.L's., holding cam levers; T., tension; 000., set row counter at 000; M.B., main bed.

SWEATER

BACK

Ribbers Using A. Cast on 57 (63, 69) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T3/3 K. 10 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 29 (32, 35) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to A T5. K. 19 rows. Make a hem and K, the row.

hem and K. the row.

All machines 000. T6. Change to B. foll. chart K. to 62 (78, 94) rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 2 rows. * Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and every foll. 4th row 16 (18, 20) times in all, then every alt. row twice. 17 (19, 21) sts. rem. Using A. K. 1 row.

NECKBAND

Ribbers Transfer alt. sts. to ribber. T3/3. K. 8 rows. K. 1 loose row, Transfer ribber sts. to M.B. and cast off chain method.

Single machines Transfer alt. sts. to adjacent needles. Push empty needles to A position. T5. K. 16 rows. Return empty needles to B position. K. 1 loose row. Cast off chain method.

FRONT

K. as back to *. Cast off 5 sts. at centre. Push needles at left to E position. H.C.L's II. K. the right side first. Keeping neck edge straight dec. 1 st. at raglan edge on next and foll. 4th row 13 (15, 17) times. 11 (12, 13) sts. rem. Cast off 1 (2, 3) sts. at neck edge on next row then dec. 1 st. on every 4th row 3 times. At the same time continue to dec. at raglan edge as before 3 more times, then every alt. row twice. Cast off rem. 2 sts. H.C.L's I. Return needles at left to B position by hand. Rejoin wool at neck edge and K. to match right half.

SLEEVES

Ribbers Using A cast on 33 (35, 37) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T3/3 K. 10 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool. Cast on 17 (18, 19) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to A T5. K. 19 rows. Make a hem and K. the row.



All machines 000. T6. Foll. chart and working in stripes of 16 rows in each colour throughout. K. 12 rows. Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 12th row 4 (6, 8) times. 41 (47, 53) sts. K. straight to 64 (86, 110) rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 4 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 6th row 6 (4, 2) times then every 4th row 8 (13, 18) times in all. Slip rem. 9 sts. onto a knitting needle.

NECKBAND

With wrong side facing and beg. at left. Pick up 8 sts. up right front neck and 9 sts. from 1 sleeve (17 sts.). Using A K. 1 row.

Ribbers Transfer alt. sts. to ribber T3/3. K. 8 rows. K. 1 loose row, transfer ribber sts. to M.B. and cast off chain method.


Single machines Transfer alt. sts. to adjacent needles, push empty needles to A position. T5. K. 16 rows. Return empty needles to B position, K. 1 loose row and cast off chain method. K. left front to match.


BUTTONBAND

Join front raglan seams. Turn mock rib neckband to inside and slip-st. in place. With wrong side facing pick up 27 (30, 33) sts. from left front (right front for boys) and 9 sts. from neckband 36 (39, 42) sts. Using A K. 1 row.

Ribbers Transfer alt. sts. to ribber T3/3, K. 10 rows. K. 1 loose row. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B. and cast off chain method.

Single machines Transfer alt. sts. to adjacent needles. Push empty needles to A position. T5. K. 20 rows. Return empty needles to B position. K. I loose row and cast off chain method.





BUTTONHOLE BAND

Mark position on buttonband for 3 buttons. First to come in the middle of the neckband, the last 11 ins. above lower edge and the remaining one in the centre of these two.

Ribbers K. as buttonband making buttonholes on row 5 over 1 st.

Single machines K. as buttonband making buttonholes on rows 5 and 15 over 1 st.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out and press with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join back raglan, side and sleeve seams. Fold mock rib front bands in half and slip-st. in place. Sew on buttons. Press seams.

TROUSERS

LEFT LEG

All machines Using A. Cast on 43 (49, 55) sts. by hand. T6. K. 10 rows. 000. T6. foll. chart K. 8 (9, 10) rows inc. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 8th (9th, 10th) row 13 times in all 69 (75, 81) sts. K. straight to 116 (132, 148) rows. This will give a finished inside leg seam of $7\frac{1}{2}$ ($8\frac{1}{2}$, $9\frac{1}{2}$) ins. Shape to Waist

000. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 12 (14, 16) rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 14th (16th, 18th) rows 6 times in all 51 (57, 63) sts. K. 2 rows. (K. 1 row extra for right front.) Carriage at left.

Shape Back

Push up 27 (33, 39) needles at opposite end to carriage to E position. H.C.L's II. Always winding wool round first needle in E position. K. 2 rows. Push up 4 needles at opposite end to E position on next and alt. rows 5 times in all. K. 1 row. H.C.L's I. K. 1 row in stocking st.

WAISTBAND

Transfer every 3rd st. to adjacent needle. Push empty needles to A position. T5. K. 20 rows. Return empty needles to B position K. 1 loose row. Cast off chain method.

RIGHT LEG

K. to match left leg, reversing back shaping.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out and press with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Join inner leg seams to crutch, then front and back seams. Turn lower edges and waistband to inside and slip-st. in place. Thread elastic through waistband. Press seams.

HAT

Ribbers Using A. Cast on 93 (97, 101) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T3/3 K. 10 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 47 (49, 51) sts. K. a few rows. Change to A T5. K. 19 rows. Make a hem and K. the row. All machines 000. T6. Foll. chart and working in stripes of 16 rows in each colour. K. straight to 78 (86, 94) rows. Transfer every alt. st. to adjacent needle push empty needles to A position. K. 1 row. With right side of right front facing machine and working from left edge place the front edge to first 61 sts., the shaped edge to next 22 N., the straight side neck to next 26 (30, 34) N. Cast off all sts. tog. Work left band the same omitting buttonholes.

DESIGN No. 6 NECK EDGE AND FRONT BANDS

Neck Edge

Work same as neck edge for design No. 3.

Cast on 138 (147, 156) sts. Rep. from * to * as on frills. Stretch and press frill to 341 $(36\frac{1}{2}, 38\frac{1}{2})$ ins.

Right Front Band

Cast on 92 (98, 104) sts. ** T6. K. 12 rows. To make buttonholes leave the first 5 sts. on right edge, * cast off the next 4 sts., leave the next 9 (10, 11) sts. Rep. from * to last 9 sts., cast off the next 4 sts., leave the last 5 sts. Push empty N. to B pos. K. 1 row. Twist loose yarn around empty N. K. 11 rows. T8. K. 1 row. Rep. from ** once more. MDE. K. 2 rows. Place on frill. With right side of right facing machine, place the front edge evenly onto N., including the double neck edge and hem. Cast off all sts. tog. Work left band the same omitting buttonholes.

TO MAKE UP

Press all pieces. Join shoulder, neck edgings and frills at necks. Gather up sleeve tops where necessary, sew sleeves into armholes. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew up front band ends, oversew around buttonholes, press bands and sew on buttons. Sew beginnings of openings on designs No. 2 and 3. To knit rouleau cast on 3 sts. Right part button in. T3. K. rouleau to required length and cast off. Thread rouleau through bands as shown. Tie into bow. Tie very firm knots into the ends and cut away excess. Press all edgings and seams. Sew in shoulder pads into gathered sleeve tops if desired.

COR. at the same time inc. 1 st. each end of every foll. 6th (7th, 8th) rows to 78 (82, 86) sts.

Shape TopCont. in dk. for all sizes, casting off 3 (4, 5) sts. at beg. of the next 2 rows. 72 (74, 76)

sts. 000. Dec. 1 st. each end of every foll.



000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. alt. row until 33 (35, 37) sts. rem. K. 1 row. Cast off.

RIGHT FRONT

Ribbers Cast on 47 (51, 55) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 20 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 24 (26, 28) sts. on alt needles. K. a few rows change to main wool. T5. K. 39 rows. Make a hem and K. the row.

All machines 000. T7. K. 94 (104, 114) rows. (K. 1 row extra for left front.)

Shape Raglan and Neck

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next row. K. 3 rows. Dec. 1 st. at raglan edge on next and foll. alt. rows. at the same time dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next and foll. 6th row 9 (11, 12) times in all. Continue to dec. at raglan edge as before until 2 sts. rem. K. 1 row. Cast off.

LEFT FRONT

K. to match right front reversing all shapings.

SLEEVES

Ribbers Cast on 51 (53, 55) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 20 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 26 (27, 28) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to main wool. T5. K. 39 rows. Make a hem and K. the row.

All machines 000. T7. K. 10 rows. Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 8th row 13 (14, 15) times in all. 77 (81, 85) sts. K. straight to 124 (134, 144) rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 3rd row 4 times in all, then every alt. row until 11 sts. rem K. 1 row. Cast off.

FRONT BAND


Mark position on left front for 4 buttons, the first $\frac{3}{4}$ in. above lower edge and the last one at beg. of neck shaping. Space the remainder evenly between.



Tension

T6. 15 sts. and 20 rows to 2 ins. after pressing.

Abbreviations

K., knit; sts., stitches; inc., increase; dec., decrease; foll., following; alt., alternate; beg., beginning; rem., remain; T., tension; 000., set row counter at 000; M.B., main bed.

Notes

Needles in A position are counted as 1 st. when shaping. Decreasing at neck edge is worked by transferring 21 st.st. onto 22nd needle. Move all end sts. 1 needle in remembering that the 20th needle is always in A position. Decreasing must be worked before setting the lace pattern, and the S.D. moved 1 place to keep pattern correct.

BACK

Ribbers Cast on 145 (153, 161, 169) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. having extra st. at right T4/4. K. 10 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

All machines 000. T5. S.D. on 3. Foll. lace pattern. K. 42 rows. Transfer centre and every foll. 8th st. each side to adjacent needle. Return empty needles to A position, if end sts. are selected leave these in B position. T6. K. straight to 156 rows.

Shape Armholes

000. Cast off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at the beg. of next 7 rows, then every alt. row 5 (6, 6, 7) times 111 (117, 123, 129) sts. K. straight to 80 (84, 90, 94) rows.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 7 sts. at beg. of next 8 rows and 5 (7, 9, 11) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Cast off rem. 45 (47, 49, 51) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Ribbers Cast on 68 (72, 76, 80) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 10 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 34 (36, 38, 40) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. Change to main wool T4. K. 19 rows. Make a hem and K. the row. Inc. 1 st. at right edge. 68 (72, 76, 80) sts.

All machines 000. T5. S.D. on 6. Foll. lace pattern K. 42 rows. Carriage is at right.

Break wool.
POCKET

H.C.L's III. Push 28 sts. at left and 9 (13, 17, 21) sts. at right to E position. K. on rem. 31 sts. The Working in st.st. K. 18 rows. Pick up loops of first row in st.st. and place on needles. T6. K. 80 rows. Break wool. Take carriage over to right side of work. Return all needles in E position to B position by hand. H.C.L's I. Counting from

left side (front edge). Transfer the 20th and every foll. 8th st. onto adjacent needles and push empty needles to A position. 000. Keeping 19 sts. at front edge in lace K. 114 rows. (K. 1 row extra for left front.)

Shape Armhole and Neck

000. Cast off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts. at beg. of next row. K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. Ribbers Cast on 67 (71, 75, 79) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. T4/4. K. 20 rows. Transfer ribber sts. to M.B.

Single machines Using waste wool cast on 34 (36, 38, 40) sts. on alt. needles. K. a few rows. T4. Change to main wool K. 39 rows. Make a hem and K. the row.

All machines Transfer centre and every foll. 8th st. each side to adjacent needle. Push empty needles to A position. 000. T6. K. 10 rows. Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and foll.

8th row 17 times in all 101 (105, 109, 113) sts. K. straight to 156 rows.

Shape Top

000. Cast off 5 (5, 6, 6) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. at each end of next 5 rows, then every 3rd row 6 (6, 10, 10) times, then every alt. row 8 (10, 6, 8) times. 



Cast off 5 sts. at beg. of next 6 rows, and 5 (6, 7, 8) sts. at beg. of foll. 2 rows. Slip rem. 30 (32, 34, 36) sts. onto a knitting pin.

LEFT FRONT

Cast on 61 (64, 67, 70) sts. by hand. T9. K. 7 rows (6 rows on right front). Cast on 10 sts. at beg. of next row 71 (74, 77, 80) sts. K. to 16 rows. 000. T9. Foll. chart but keep 10 sts. at left side (front edge) in stocking stitch. K. 10 rows. Dec. 1 st. at beg. (side edge) of next and foll. 10th row 18 times in all 53 (56, 59, 62) sts. K. straight to 190 rows (1 extra row on right front).

Shape Armholes

* 000. Cast off 6 sts. at beg. of next row. K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. at beg. of next and foll. alt. rows 7 (8, 9, 10) times in all. 40 (42, 44, 46) sts. K. straight to 29 rows.

Cast off 5 sts. at beg. of next row. Carriage at right. Slip 5 sts. at opposite end to carriage onto a pin. K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next 6 rows. then on alt. rows until 20 (21, 22, 23) sts. rem. K. straight to 74 (76, 78, 80) rows.

K. straight to 130 rows. (1 extra row on right front.)



With waste wool cast on 65 sts. K. a few rows. Change to main wool. T7. K. 2 rows. S.D. 3. Press buttons 1 and 5 H.C.L's III. K. 4 rows. H.C.L's I. K. 2 rows. Foll. chart K. 64 rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of next and foll. alt. rows 11 times in all. K. 1 row 39 sts. rem. Slip sts. onto a knitting pin.

LEFT FRONT

With waste wool cast on 33 sts. K. a few rows. Change to main wool. T7. K. edging as back. 000. Foll. chart K. 64 rows. (1 extra row on Right Front).

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next row. K. 1 row. Dec. 1 st. at beg. of next and foll. alt. rows 11 times in all. K. 1 row 20 sts. rem. Slip sts. onto a knitting pin.

RIGHT FRONT

K. as left front reversing all shapings and omitting last row to keep pattern correct.

SLEEVES

With waste wool, cast on 37 sts. K. a few rows. T7. K. edging as back. 000. Foll. chart K. 8 rows. Inc. 1 st. each end of next and foll. 8th row 6 times in all. 49 sts. K. straight to 56 rows.

Shape Raglan

000. Cast off 2 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of next on foll. alt. row 11 times in all. K. 1 row. 23 sts. rem. Slip sts. onto a knitting pin.

YOKE

Bring forward 100 needles to B position. With plain side of work facing place 20 sts. from left front onto first 14 needles (dec. 6 sts. evenly) 23 sts. from left sleeve, 39 sts. from back onto next 26 needles (dec. 13 sts. evenly) 23 sts. from right sleeve, 20 sts. from right front on last 14 needles (dec. 6 sts. evenly) T7. K. 14 rows. Slip sts. onto a knitting needle. Bring forward 67 needles to B position. Replace sts. on machine (dec. 33 sts. evenly along row) T6. K. 10 rows. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out and press with a warm iron over a damp cloth. Unravel waste wool, pick up loops and cast off with a knitting needle. Join sides, sleeve and remainder of raglan seams. Using crochet hook, work 2 rows of



double crochet up fronts and round neck. Next row Work 1 row of looped pattern (as shown) up front then trebles round neck and looped pattern down other front. Thread ribbon through holes at neck. Sew buttons on one front to match loops. Press seams.

LEGGINGS LEFT LEG

Cast on 33 sts. over alt. needles by hand. T6. K. 19 rows. Bring empty needles to B position K, the row. 65 sts. 000. T7. K. 1 row. (K. 1 row extra for Right Leg.)

Shape Back

H.C.L's II. Always winding wool round first needle in E position, push 7 sts. at opposite end to carriage to E position on next and foll. alt. rows 5 times in all. K. 1 row. H.C.L's I. K. 4 rows. Inc. 1 st. at each end of next and foll. 6th row until there are 87 sts. K. straight to 80 rows.

Shape to Ankle

000. Cast off 3 sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of next 3 rows and foll. alt. rows 10 times in all. 55 sts. K. 3 rows. Dec. 1 st. each end of next and foll. 4th row until 35 sts. rem. K. straight to 70 rows. Eyelet holes for ribbon Trans. alt. sts. to adjacent needles. K. 4 rows. Break wool.

Shape Foot

Slip 9 sts. from each end onto 2 safety pins. Work on centre sts. only. Inc. 1 st. at beg. of next row. K. 20 rows.

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Shape Toe

* H.C.L's II. Always winding wool round first needle in E pos. Push 1 needle at opposite end to carriage to E pos. on next 10 rows and back to C pos. on next 10 rows. * H.C.L's I. K. straight for 20 rows.

Shape Heel

K. as toe from * to *. Slip sts. onto a pin. Push 18 needles to B pos. With right side facing replace 18 sts. from heel on machine. With wrong side facing replace the 2 sets of 9 sts. on top of 18 sts. placing outer edges to centre. Cast off the 2 sets of sts. together.



You can take out the machine and pick up the course exactly when you feel like it and all in the comfort of your own home.



inc. £3.00 of wool

ladies tabard



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Materials

10 (11, 12, 13) ozs. Templetons Nylonised 4 ply wool, 4 (4, 5, 5) ozs. Templetons Ayrwave double knitting wool. Medium size crochet hook.

Measurements

To fit bust or chest sizes 34 (36, 38, 40) ins. Finished measurements 35 (37, 39, 41) ins. Length to shoulder 26 $(26\frac{1}{2}, 27, 27\frac{1}{2})$ ins.

Tension

T7. 25 sts. and 42 row to 4 ins.

Abbreviations

K., knit; sts., stitches; inc., increase; dec., decrease; alt., alternate; foll., following; rem., remain; beg., beginning; H.C.L's., holding cam levers; T., tension; 000., set row counter at 000.

Note

Set carriage to weaving when following chart.

BACK

Beginning at right edge. Cast on 109 (115, 121, 127) sts. by hand. K. 1 row. 000. T7. Following weaving pattern K. straight to 194 rows.

Shape Armholes

000. Cast off 13 (14, 15, 16) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows * K. straight to 80 (84, 88, 94) rows.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 6 sts. at beg. of next 6 rows, and 7 (8, 9, 10) sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Cast off rem. 33 (35, 37, 39) sts.

FRONT

K. as back to * K. straight to 36 (38, 40, 42) rows.

Shape Neck


Cast off 15 (17, 19, 21) sts. at centre. Slip sts. at left onto a knitting needle. K. the right side first. Keeping armhole edge straight dec. 1 st. at neck edge on next 5 rows, then every alt. row 4 times. 25 (26, 27, 28) sts. K. straight to 80 (84, 88, 94) rows.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 6 sts. at beg. of next and foll. alt. row 3 times in all. K. 1 row. Cast off rem. 7 (8, 9, 10) sts. Replace sts. on machine. K. to match right side reversing shaping.

TO MAKE UP

Join shoulder and side seams, leaving lower 7 ins. (or required length) open for vents. Using 4 ply work 2 rows of double crochet all round outer edges and armholes. Make a twisted cord if required.



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
