We have fought the inevitable for more than a year now, during that time there has been 3 increases in Postage costs, 2 general wage increases and 3 increases in printing costs.















All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

-  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

-  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.

-  Pattern Stitch

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as [12/14] and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1
6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

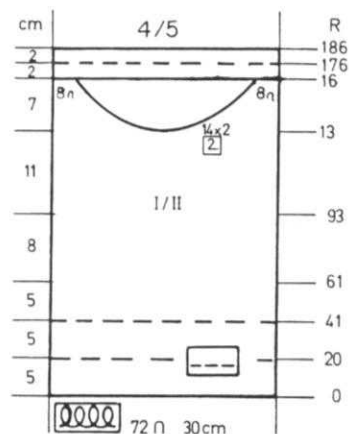

CHILD'S PULLOVER & BERMUDA SHORTS

SIZE: 4/5
 YARN: Amore
 GRAMS:
 color 1 150
 color 2 50
 color 3 50
 color 4 50
 color 5 50
 TENSION: 6 or 7
 GAUGE: 12 sts. 20 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Norwegian Design with color stripes. Punch your own Card.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Sew center seam of pants to marking. Make hem at waist then pull elastic through casing. Overlap back over front shoulder - 10 cm (4") See Picture. then sew in sleeves.



FRONT & BACK: I/II Both sections the same.

Bring 72 needles into working position then push back to the out of work position every 3rd needle for a MOCK RIB.

With waste yarn, cast on over the remaining needles in work.

Work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Work 20 rows color 1 and work the color stripes as follows:

6 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 4, 2 rows color 5, 6 rows color 1.

Bring all the empty needles into working position and hang the hem.

Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1 to Row 61. Put in Bear Punch Card and set the first row of Pattern from left to right then work the Bear (Norwegian Technique) design with color 1 and 2. When Bear is completed, continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1.

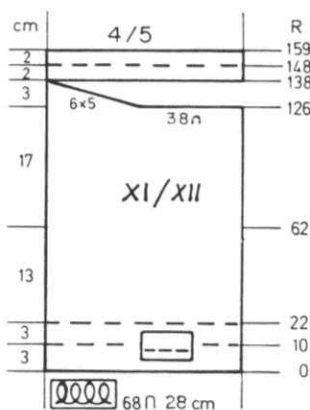
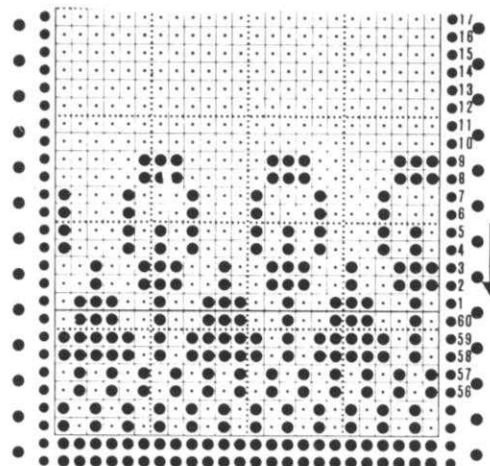
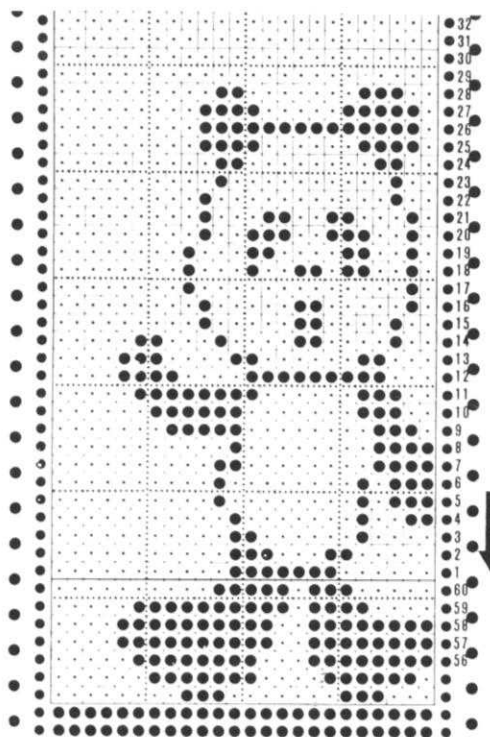
After Row 93, mark each side for setting in sleeves.

After Row 138, put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, (using SHORT ROWS for shaping neck), put into holding position 2 sts. 14x. Put all these sts. into holding position, and work the left half. Knit 1 row across (from center to left side) over the needles, then turn the Row Counter to 138 and complete the left half, following the instructions from *.

After Row 166, bring all the needles into working position and work the color stripes of 2 rows color 5, 2 rows color 4, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 1.

Hang every 3rd st. onto neighboring needle and with color 1, work 10 rows. Hang the hem (first row of band color) or you can sew the band down to the inside later. Bind off loosely.



SHORTS: Make 1, reverse 1 -XI/XII

Bring 68 needles into working position, then push back EVERY 2nd NEEDLE to the OUT OF WORK position.

With Waste yarn, cast on over the remaining needles. Knit 8 to 10 rows then change to color 5 and put Counter at 0.

Knit 10 rows, then work the color stripes of

2 rows color 5, 2 rows color 4, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 5, 2 rows color 1.

Bring the empty needles into working position and hang the hem.

Put in Flower Card.

Work 4 color 1, setting the Card after Row 3 (from left to right).

Work 10 Rows colors 1 & 4,

6 rows colors 1 & 3.

STOP CARD. Continue in Stockinette stitch with stripes of

*4 rows color 1, 4 rows color 5,

4 rows color 2, 4 rows color 3,

4 rows color 4.

REPEAT THE STRIPES from * 3x and mark each side after Row 62.

Work 4 rows color 1 then continue with color 5.

After Row 127, work SHORT ROWS:

Put into holding position 38 sts.

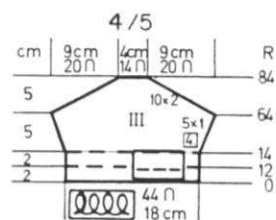
then 5 sts. 6x.

Bring all the needles into working position and knit the band.

With color 1, knit 10 rows.

Transfer every 3rd st. to neighboring needle and knit 10 rows.

Hang the hem then bind off loosely.



SLEEVES: III

Bring 44 needles into working position then push back every 3 needle to the out of work position.

Cast on over the remaining needles with waste yarn. After knitting 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1 and work 12 rows Stockinette stitch. Work the 10 rows of color stripes same as front and back, then bring all empty needles into working position and hang the hem.

Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 5x.

After Row 64, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 2 sts. 10x.

After Row 84, bind off the remaining stitches.

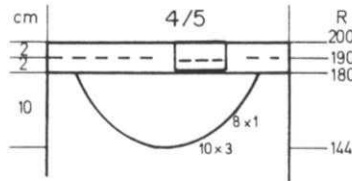

SIZE: 4/5
 YARN: Amore
 GRAMS:
 color 1 200
 color 2 100
 color 3 50
 TENSION: 3 to 6
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")



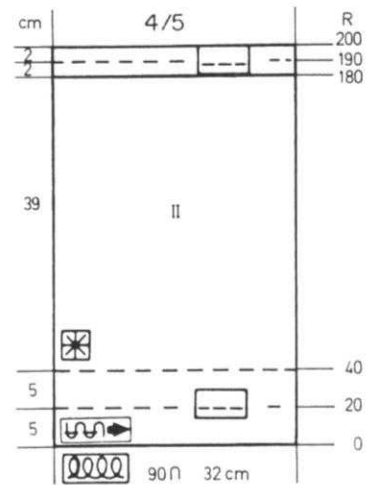
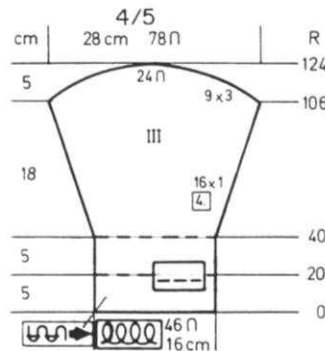
A Norwegian Design with color stripes. Punch your own Card. Bands are Mock Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Bring back forward over front neckline approximately 10 cm (4") as shown in picture. Shorts: Fold each section and sew up leg seam for 17 cm (7"). Sew front and back seams. Pull elastic through casing at waist.



FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 144. Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, put into holding position 3 sts. 10x, 1 st. 8x. After Row 180, put all these sts. into holding position and bring the Carriage to the left side. Turn the Row Counter back to 144 and leave the RIGHT HALF sts. in holding position and push the left side sts. to working position. Work the Short Rows the same as the right side, following the instructions from *. After Row 180, bring all the needles into working position. Transfer every 3rd stitch to neighboring needle and work the Mock Rib band same as you did for the back.



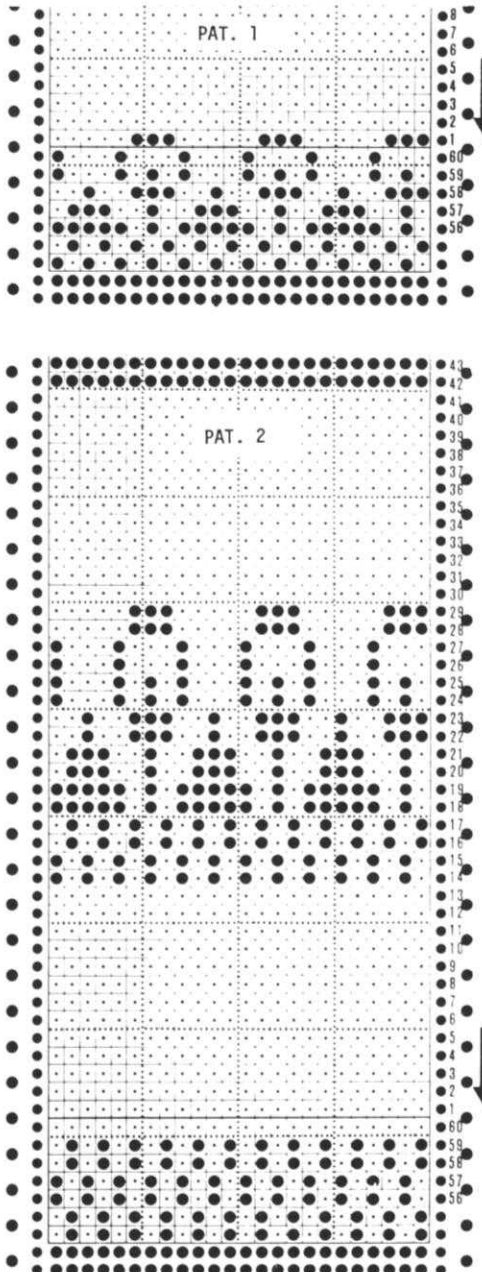
BACK: II

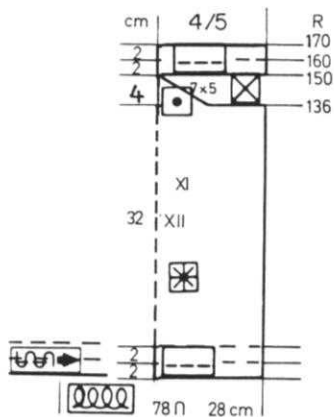
Bring 90 sts. into working position. Push every 3rd st. back to the out of work position and with waste yarn Cast on over the remaining sts. Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Knit 24 rows color 1, then 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 3, 6 rows color 1. After Row 40, bring the empty needles into working position and hang the hem. Continue in Stockinette stitch and PATTERN II.

*Work 12 rows Stockinette stitch with color 1, then work the FLOWER SECTION of Pattern II with 10 rows using colors 1 and 3, then 6 rows with colors 1 and 2. REPEAT from * 1 time more, then **work 12 rows Stockinette stitch with color 1 then work the FLOWER of Pattern I with 5 rows using colors 1 and 3 then 3 rows with colors 1 and 2. REPEAT from ** 1 time more then knit to Row 180 with color 1. Transfer every 3rd stitch to neighboring needle and work Mock Rib with 4 rows color 3, 2 rows color 2, 4 rows color 3, 10 rows color 1, then hang the hem and bind off loosely.

SLEEVES: III

Bring 46 needles into working position and push back every 3rd to the out of work position. Cast on over the remaining needles with waste yarn. Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Work the 40 rows of Stripes same as you did for the front and back then bring the empty needles into work and hang the hem. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 16x. After Row 106, SHAPE CAP. ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 9x. After Row 124, bind off the remaining sts.





SHORTS: XI/XII - Front & Back.
Make 1, reverse 1.

Bring 78 needles into working position then push back every 3rd needle to the out of work position. With contrast waste yarn, cast on over the remaining needles. Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Knit 10 rows color 1. Bring the empty needles into working position and continue in Stockinette stitch with stripes of 2 rows color 1, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 1. Hang the hem then work 4 rows color 1.

Work PATTERN II right from the beginning - 2 rows color 1 and 3, 2 rows color 1 and 2, 2 rows color 1 and 3. Work the stripes in Stockinette stitch - 2 rows color 1, 4 rows color 2, 4 rows color 3, 4 rows color 1 - work the FLOWER PATTERN - 10 rows colors 1 and 3, 6 rows colors 1 and 2. Continue in REPEATED color stripes of 4 rows color 3, 4 rows color 2, 4 rows color 1. After Row 137, ON OPPOSITE SIDE of Carriage, put into holding position 35 sts. then on every 2nd row, put into holding position, 5 sts. 7x. Bring all the needles into working position and mark the next row for hem then knit to Row 170. Hang the marked row and bind off loosely. Be sure to REVERSE the shaping on 2nd section.

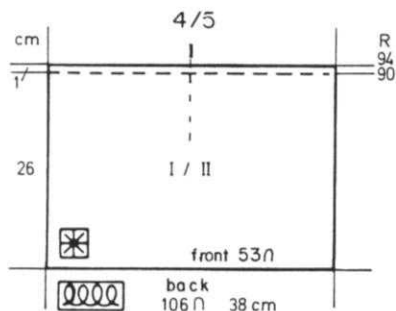

SIZE: 4/5
YARN: Amore
GRAMS:
color 1 150
color 2 100
color 3 50
color 4 50
color 5 50
TENSION: 6 or 7
GAUGE: 14 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2")



A Norwegian Design and Stockinette stitch with color stripes. Punch your own Card. Bands are Stockinette stitch with color stripes.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Make heavy twisted cords to pull through neck and waist casings. SHORTS: Sew up 5 1/2" (14 cm) for leg seams then sew front and back seams. Make hem at waist if you did not hang the hem then pull elastic through casing.

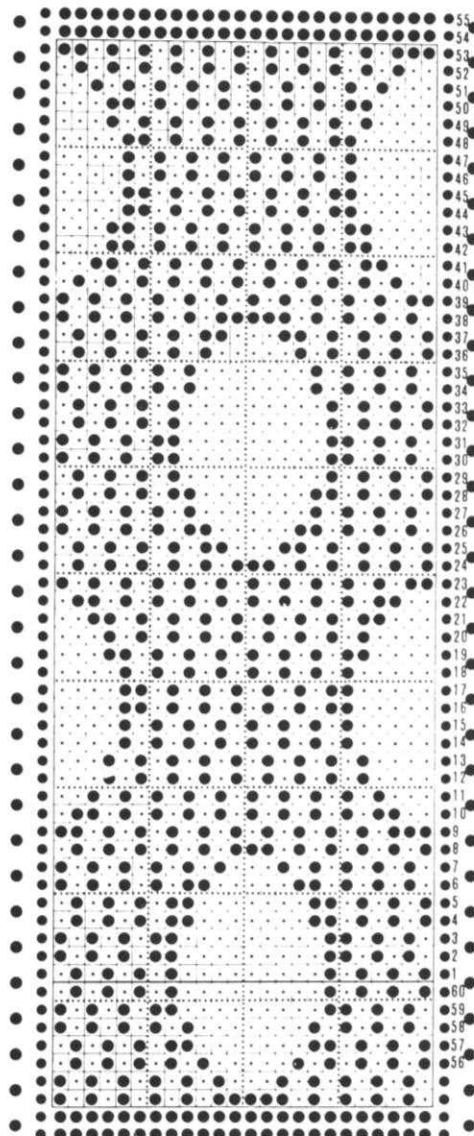


JACKET BACK: II

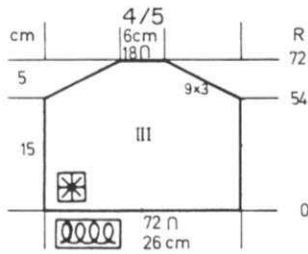
With contrast waste yarn, cast on 106 sts. Knit 8 to 10 rows then change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Knit 6 rows color 1, then work the Norwegian Design with colors 1 & 2. After Row 90, bind off or remove onto waste yarn, center 54 sts. Put the left side into holding position and work the right saddle shoulder as follows in Stockinette stitch.
*4 rows color 1, 4 rows color 2, 4 rows color 3, 4 rows color 4, 4 rows color 1. Bind off or remove onto waste yarn. Bring the needles on the left into working position and REPEAT from * for left shoulder.

JACKET FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 53 sts. using waste yarn same as you did for the back. After knitting 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Knit 6 rows color 1 then work the Norwegian Design with color 1 and 2 to Row 74. ON NECK SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 2x. After Row 90, continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1 to Row 94. Bind off - or you can hang 1 shoulder of back to the remaining sts. and then bind them off together.

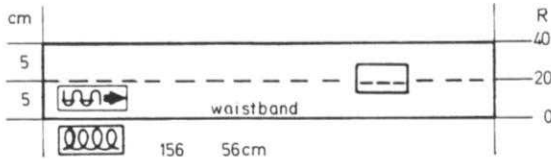


SHORTS: XI/XII Make 1, reverse 1.



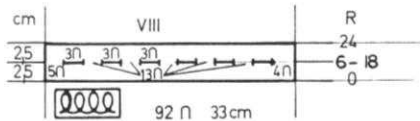
SLEEVES: III

Cast on 72 sts. using waste yarn same as you did for front and back. Work the same as front and back to Row 54.
SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 9x.
After Row 72, bind off the remaining stitches.



WAISTBAND: Sew side seams of Jacket first.

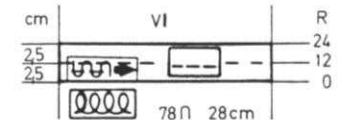
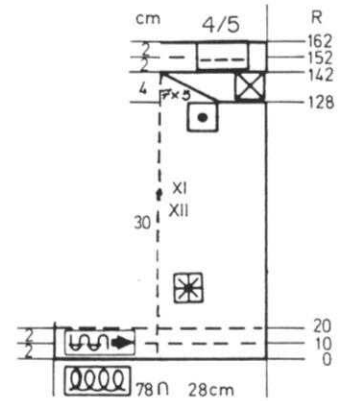
Cast on 156 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as follows: 24 rows color 1, 4 rows color 4, 4 rows color 5, 4 rows color 3, 4 rows color 2. Hang the hem and then hang the open sts. of Jacket waist to these sts. doubling the sts. evenly as needed. Bind off loosely. Another way you can do is to knit the band and do not hang the hem but hang the Jacket waist to the one set of sts. bind off then sew the other edge of band to the inside.



FRONT BANDS: Make 1 and 1 without BUTTONHOLES.

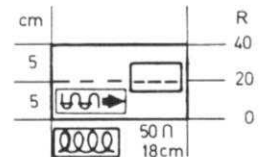
Cast on 92 sts. and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes same as Neckband. After Row 24, finish same as Neckband. Make Buttonhole band the same except make BUTTONHOLES after Rows 6 and 18 over 3 sts. leaving 5 sts. at one end and 4 at other end with 13 sts. between each buttonhole as shown on the Chart. After Row 24, complete same as button band.

NECKBAND: VI

Cast on 78 sts. and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as follows: 12 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 3, 2 rows color 5, 2 rows color 4, 2 rows color 1. Finish same as waistband.



SLEEVE BANDS:

Cast on 50 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes same as the Waistband. After Row 40, finish off same as you did for the Waistband.

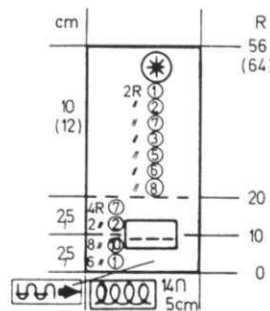

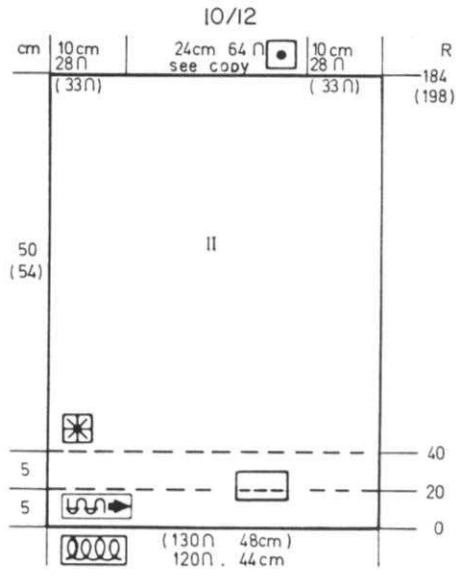
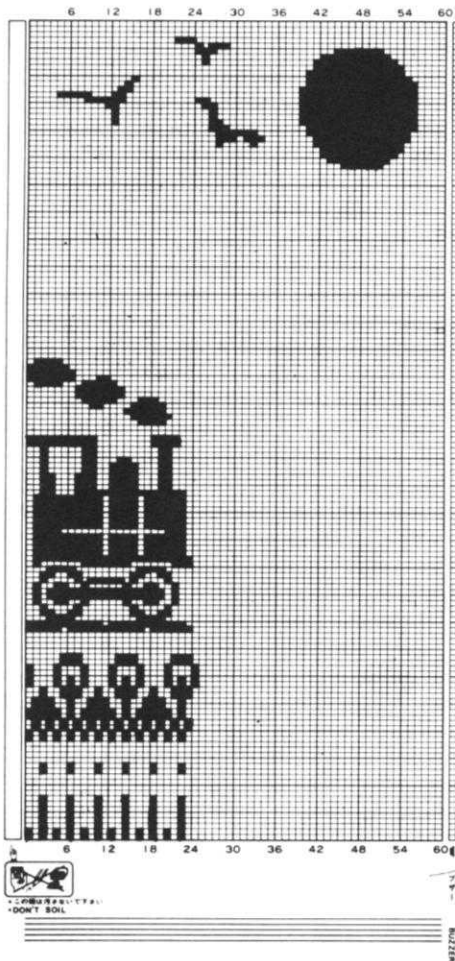

SADDLE SHOULDER STRIPS: Make 2.

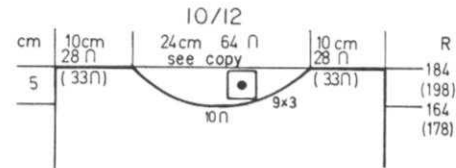
Bring 14 needles into working position and push back every 3rd needle to the out of work position. Cast on and work the Mock Rib same as you did before, working the color stripes as shown on the Chart. 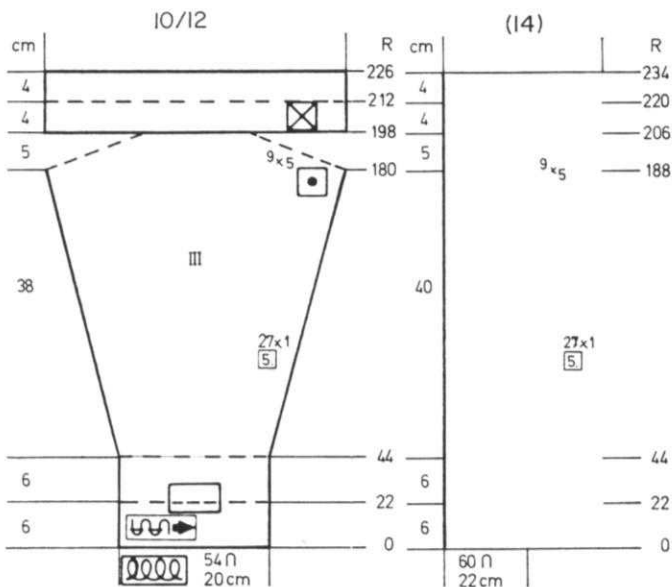

Continue with color 1 to Row 184, 198. SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK. ON EACH SIDE, bind off 28 (33) sts. then over the center 64 sts. transfer every 3rd st. to the neighboring needle and continue in color stripes of 4 rows color 7, 2 rows color 2, 8 rows color 10, 6 rows color 1. Hang the hem for band and bind off loosely.

Bring 54, (60) needles into working position and push back every 3rd needle to the out of work position. Use the same cast on as you did for the front and back then after the waste knitting, put Counter at 0 and work color stripes for the mock rib as follows: 32 rows color 1, 4 rows color 3, 4 rows color 2, 4 rows color 7. After Row 176 (180) bind off the center 30 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off

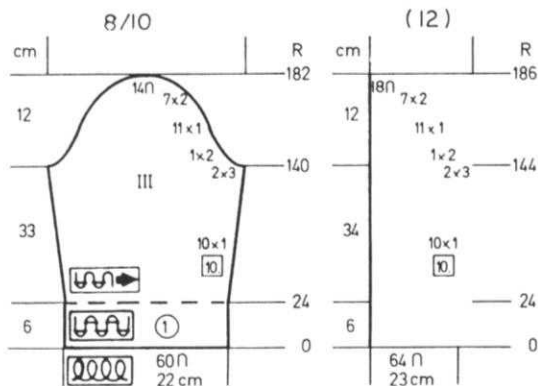
12 sts. 2x.

(13 sts. 2x).

FOR NECK, bind off 5 sts. 1x for both sizes.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter

back to 176 (180) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



SLEEVES: III

Cast on 60 (64) sts. with color 1 and work 24 rows Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 10x.

After Row 140 (144) SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 11x, 2 sts. 7x.

After Row 182 (186), bind off the remaining sts.

NECKBAND:

Cast on 133 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. every 2nd row 3x. Bind off or remove onto contrast waste yarn.

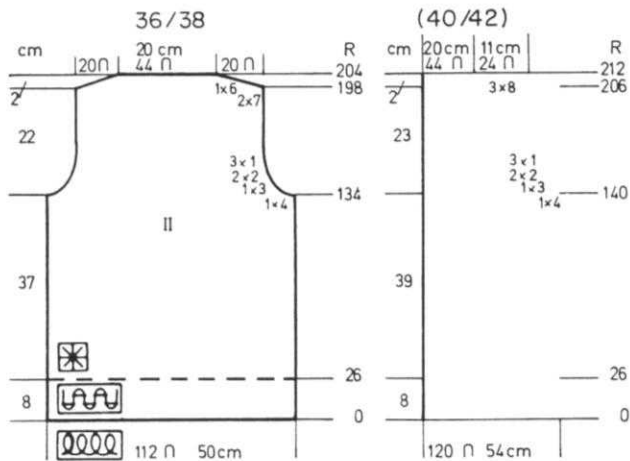

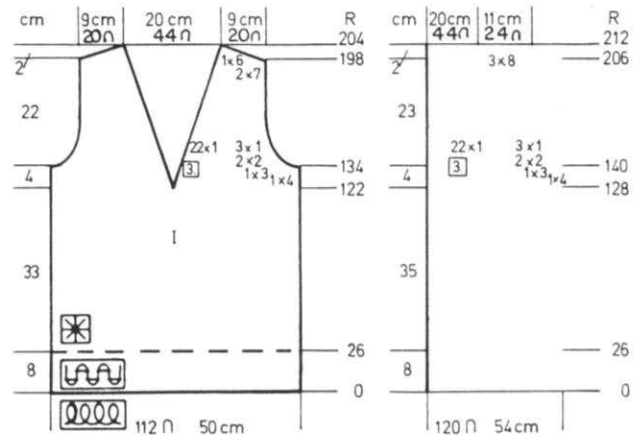
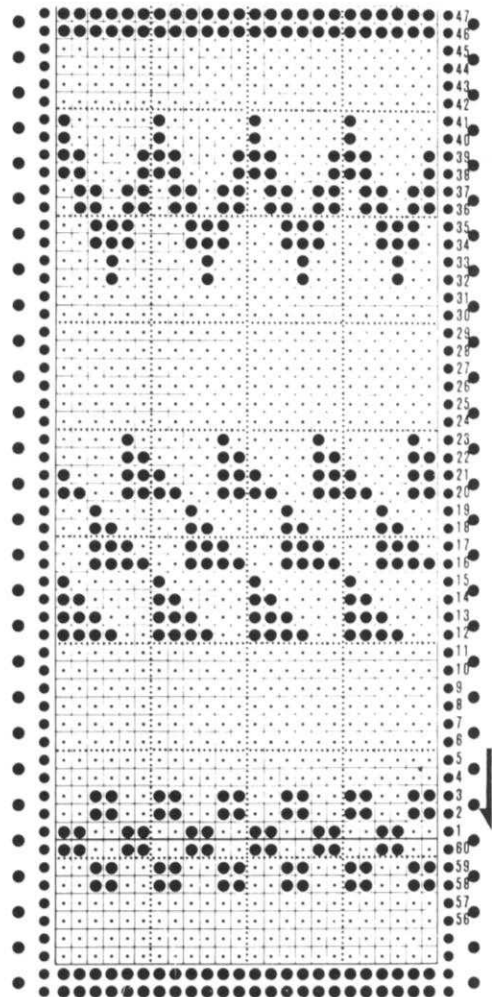

 4 rows color 2, 4 rows color 3, 13 rows color 3 and 1,
 4 rows color 3, 4 rows color 1, 10 rows color 1 and 2,
 4 rows color 1.
 REPEAT THE PATTERN THROUGHOUT.
 After Row 134 (140) SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x for both sizes.
 After Row 198 (206) SHAPE SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 7 sts. 2x, 6 sts. 1x. (8 sts. 3x).
 After Row 204 (212), bind off the remaining sts. or remove them onto contrast waste yarn.

NECKBAND:

Cast on 187 sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing same as front and back.
 ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. EVERY ROW. After Row 10, bind off or remove onto waste yarn.

ARBANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 148 sts. and work the 10 rows of Ribbing same as Neckband.



FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 122 (128). Divide in the center. Put half the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. MARK ROW ON CARD. *ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 3rd row 22x AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 134 (140), SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back.
 After Row 198 (206), SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
 Bring the needles on the left into working position, Set Card Row and knit in Pattern. Complete the left half. (Row Counter at 122 (128). Follow the Instructions from *.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

KNITTING KNITKING MAGAZINE PATTERNS ON YOUR JUMBO AND BULKY MACHINES.

It is possible to knit some of the BASIC SHAPES from KNITTING MAGAZINE Patterns on your Bulky machines. You cannot use the Pattern Designs as given, but you can make up your own designs. If you will remember to use HALF the number of stitches and HALF the number of rows shown in a Pattern, most of the time you should have no problems. You do however have to shape the sections in the same way. If an armhole bind off is 8 sts., you should bind off 4. If the total armhole bind offs are 16 sts. on each side, you should make your total bind-offs 8 on each side... etc., etc. The neck and shoulder shapings should be worked in the same manner - half the number of stitches shown for the neck bind-offs and of course half the number of stitches shown for the shoulder shaping. It may seem complicated to you at first, but try a simple pattern and see how it works out. You can also check this out with your Converta Tape to be sure that the yarn you want to use on your bulky machine is close enough to the stitch and row gauge divided IN HALF when you make up a sample swatch. If it is not, try changing the tension and make another sample and check again. You might need to make several sample swatches before you find the correct tension which will give you the stitch and row gauge you need.

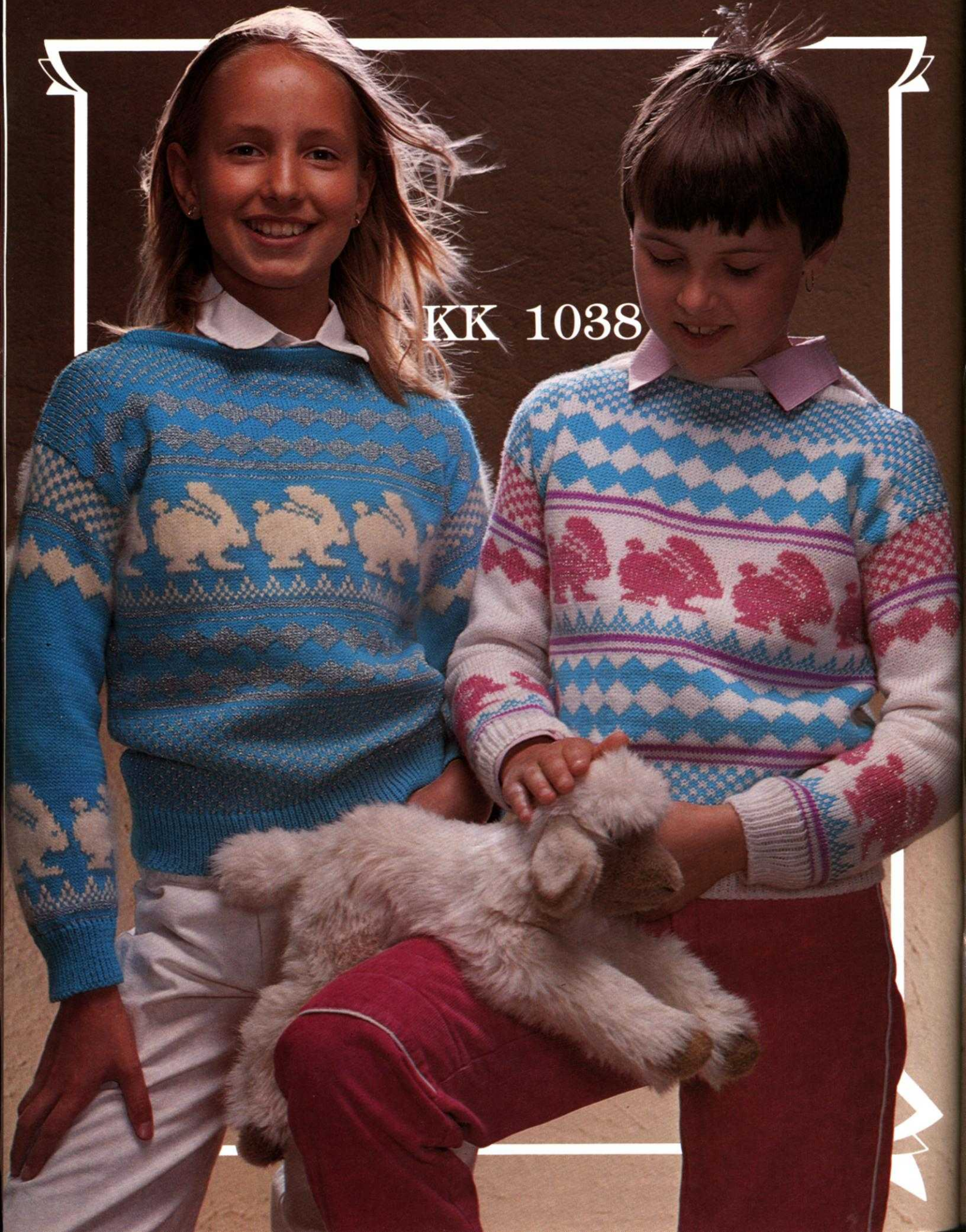

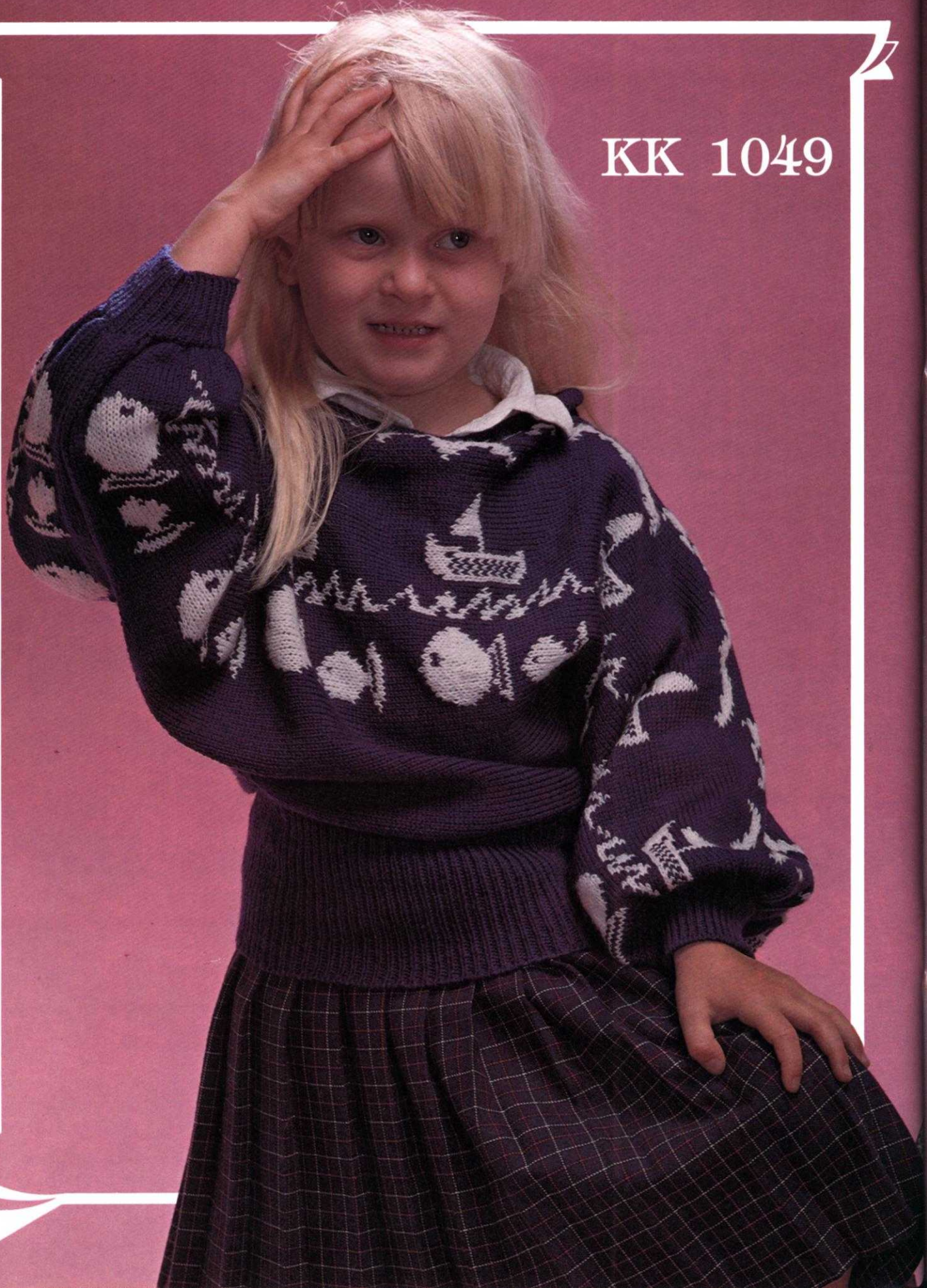




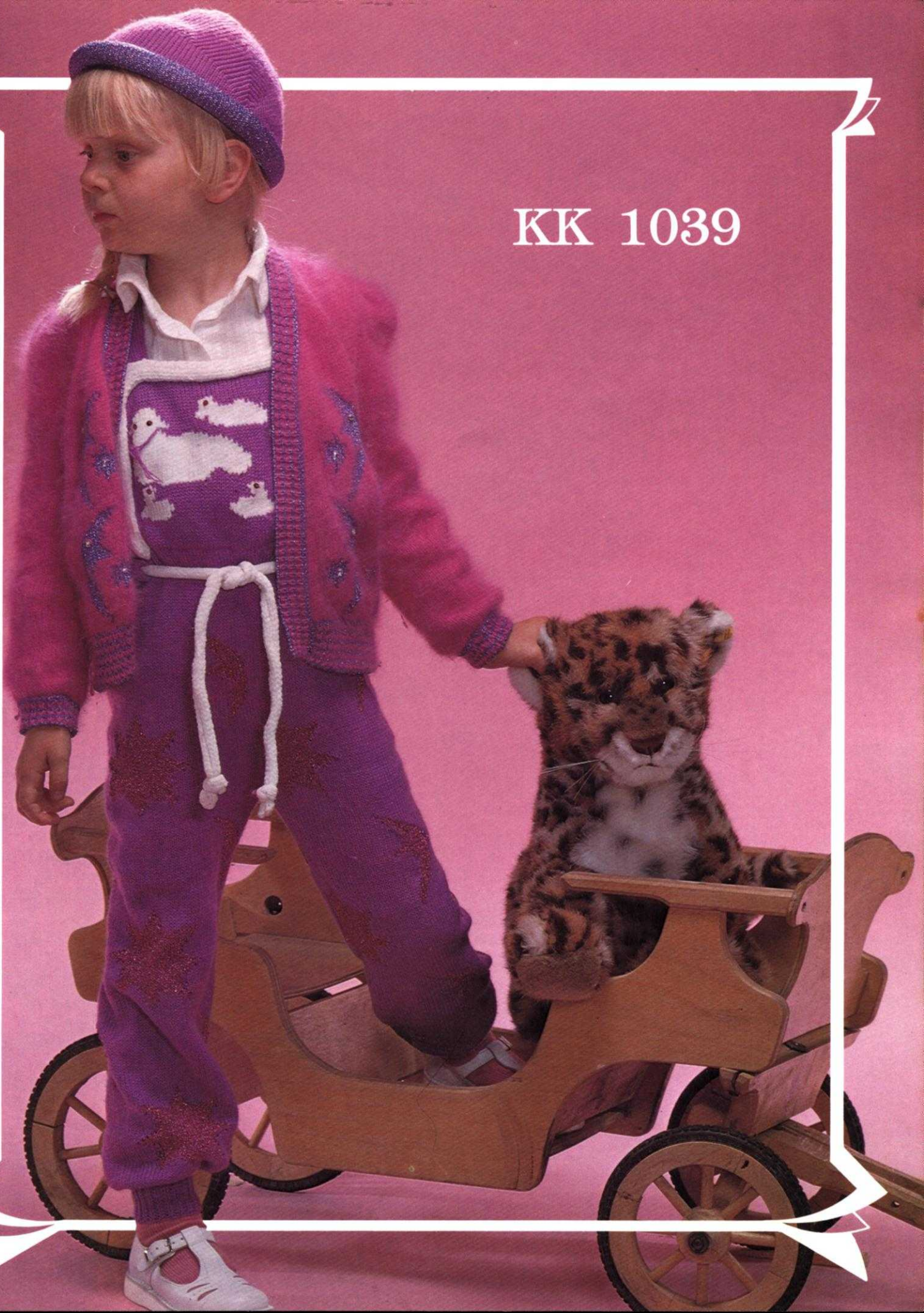
