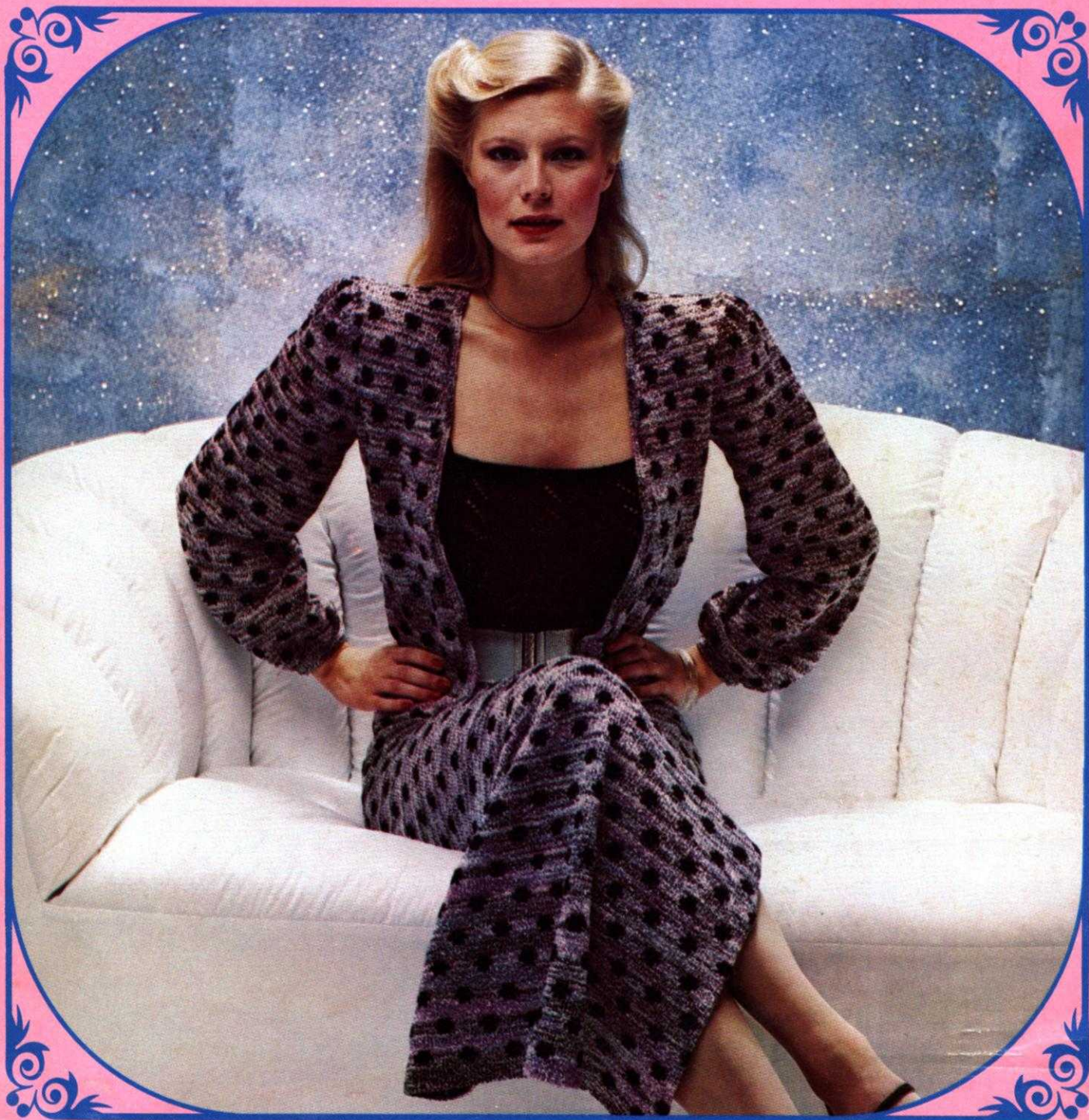


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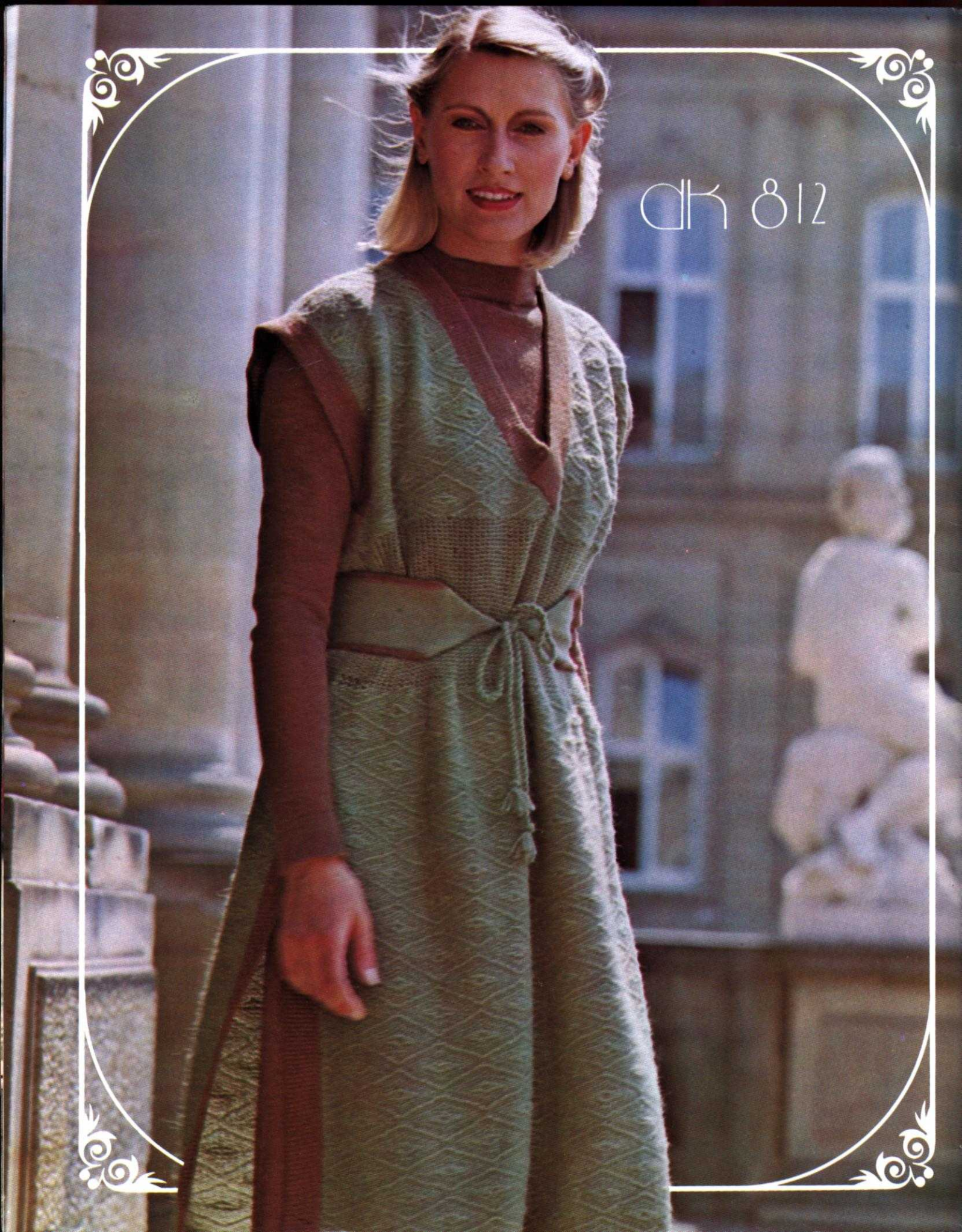


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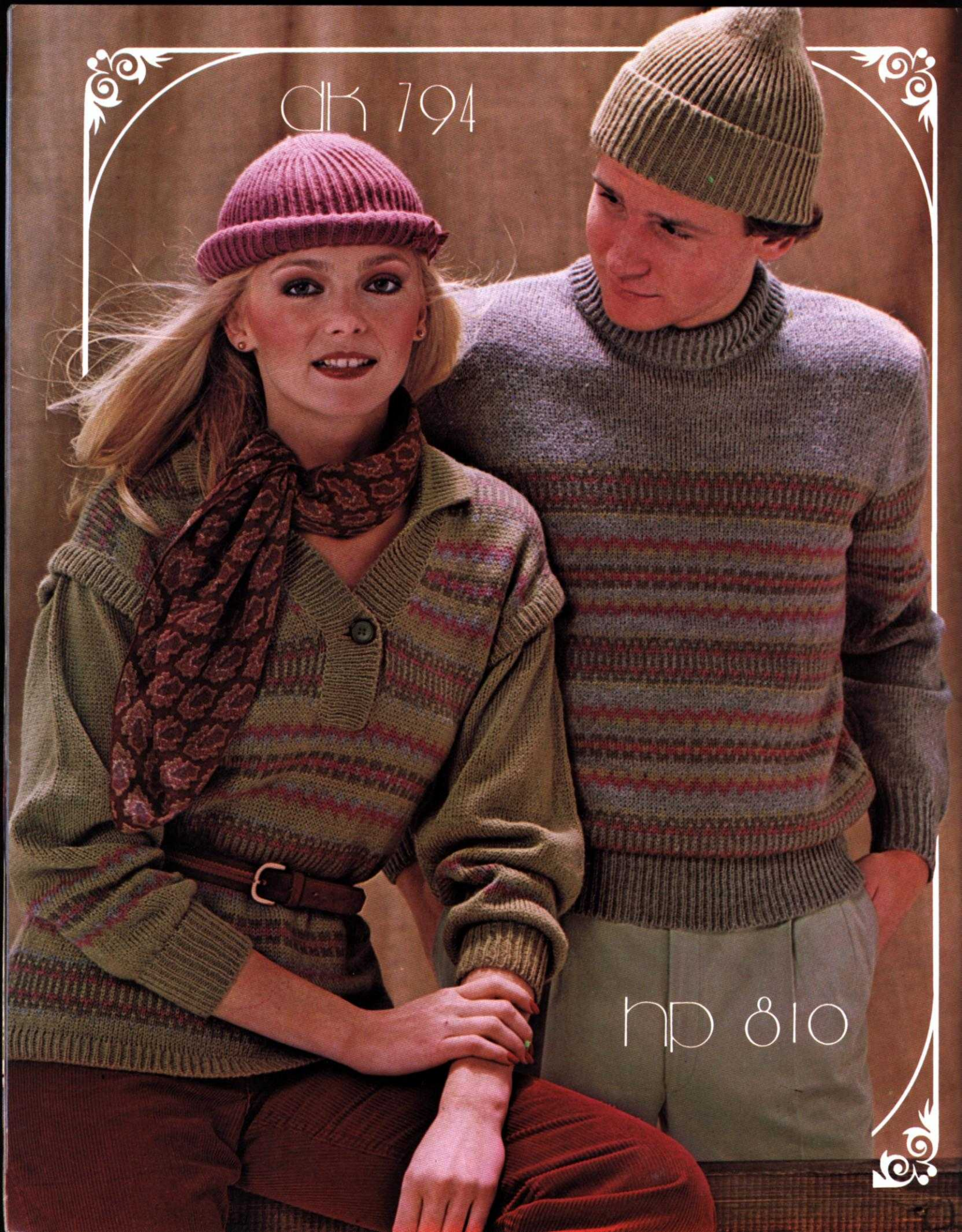

editorial

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During our visit to Japan in October last, my wife and I made a whirlwind tour to the offices and factories of our main suppliers... The hospitality afforded us every step of the way was beyond anything we have experienced in any other country of the world and we thank our friends at Juki who manufacture our BABY LOCK sewing machines... at Belna who make our BELLINKY seaming machines... at Corona who make our JUMBO machines and at BROTHER INDUSTRIES where we saw KH 840 knitting machines actually being assembled and pouring off the assembly line one complete (packed for shipping) machine every few minutes.

BROTHER INDUSTRIES occupies an area covering several city blocks in Nagoya and we were tremendously impressed with the excellent working conditions... the extreme efficiency of their entire operation... the obvious skills, speed and 'happy in the job' atmosphere given out by the line workers.. When our mechanics in Los Angeles service a machine, it takes up to 20 minutes to replace 200 needles... the worker on the line at BROTHER displayed the skill and dexterity of a magician as she fanned out (in groups of 40) 200 needles and dropped them precisely into their machine slots in less than 20 seconds...! Each machine is checked several times as it travels on a conveyor belt from one assembler to another and every machine is knitted on twice with actual yarn to check the accuracy of punch cards and lacemakers.

It was interesting to note that every garment made in BROTHER INDUSTRIES garment design workshop is always drawn first on a Knitleader Chart... and that a Knitleader is considered a most essential part of every BROTHER machine sold in Japan... in fact, every knitting machine school and teaching center starts instruction with the Knitleader... so .. if you have a neglected Knitleader, take a tip from the experts and start using it now. You will wonder how you ever knitted without it.

The knitting machine research and development department at BROTHER INDUSTRIES is a top secret area... not open to any visitors, but we talked with the head man there and we can promise you... some sensational developments can be expected in the future.

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General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1

[6] The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...
3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x].
As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITTING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITTING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.


When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")


If you do not own a KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1  means decrease (or increase) 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

 Increase

 Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

 3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

 Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.



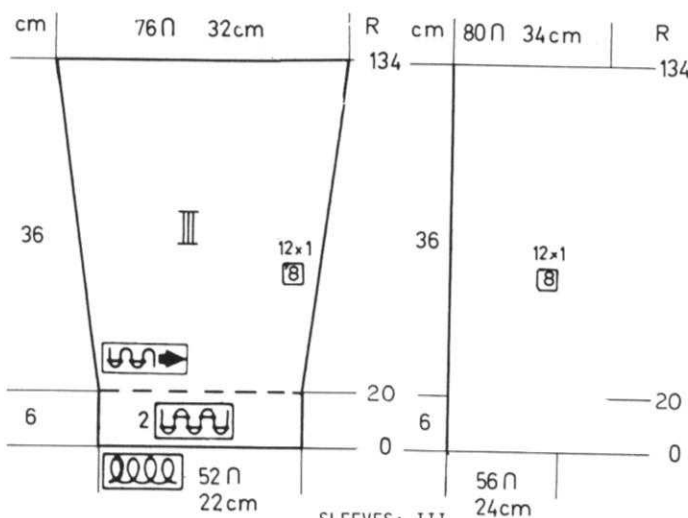
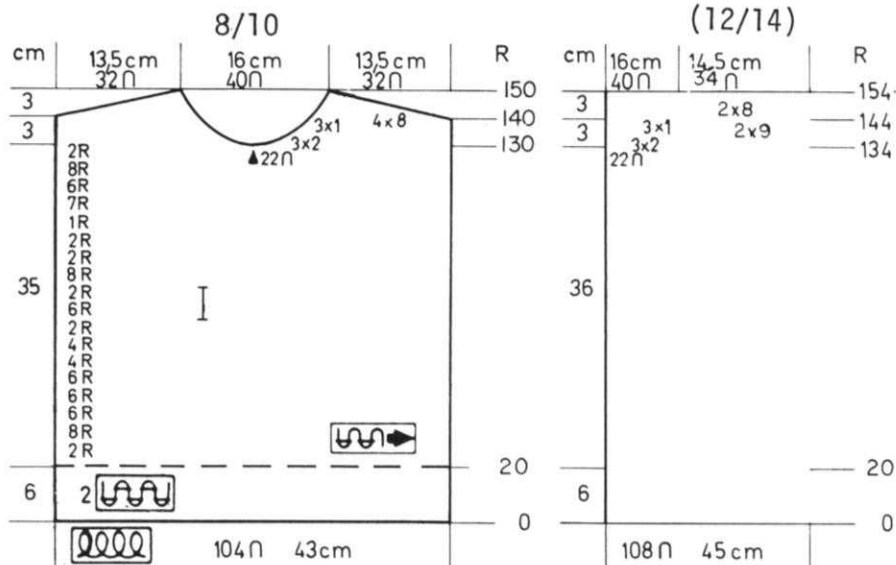

CHILD'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14)
 YARN: Sport Weight
 GRAMS: color 2 100 150
 10 - 50 gram balls of different mixed colors (See picture).
 You can mix your own colors from left over yarns.
 TENSION: 7 to 10
 GAUGE: 12 sts. 16 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with color stripes according to Chart. Bands and Collar are K2, P2 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



FRONT: I

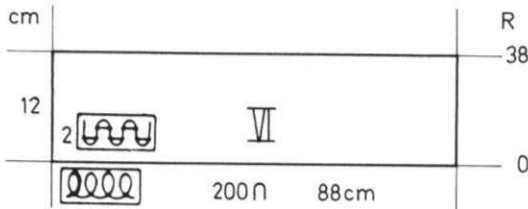
Cast on 104 (108) sts. with color 2 and work 20 rows Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 130 (134), bind off the center 22 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x for both sizes AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 140 (144) SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off 8 sts. 4x. (9 sts. 2x, 8 sts. 2x). Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 130 (134) and complete the left half (watch stripes). Follow the instructions from *.

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 52 (56) sts. with color 2 and work 20 rows Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes same as front and back.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 12x for both sizes. After Row 134, bind off.

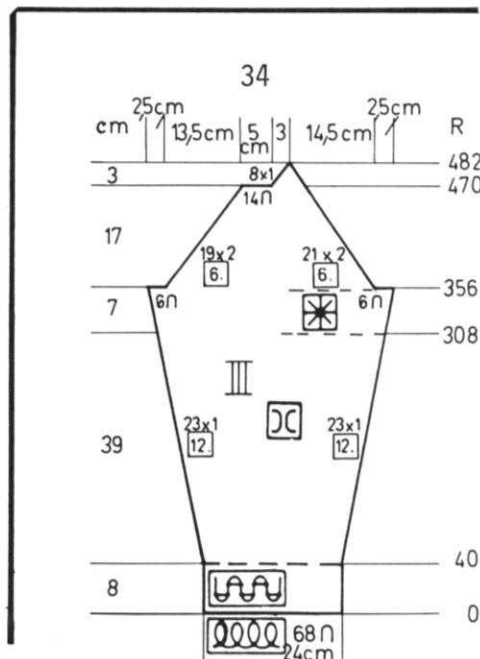
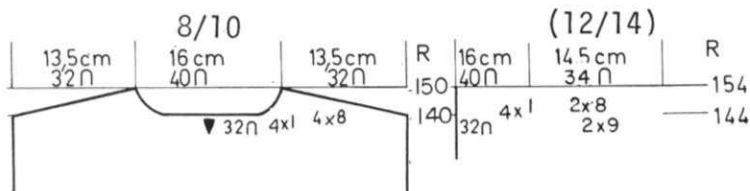
BACK: II

Work the back the same as the front to row 140 (144). Bind off the center 32 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.
 *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.
 FOR SHOULDER, bind off 8 sts. 4x, (9 sts. 2x, 8 sts. 2x),
 FOR NECK: bind off 1 st. 4x for both sizes.
 Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 140 (144) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



COLLAR: VI

Cast on 200 sts. with color 2 and work 38 rows Ribbing. Bind off.

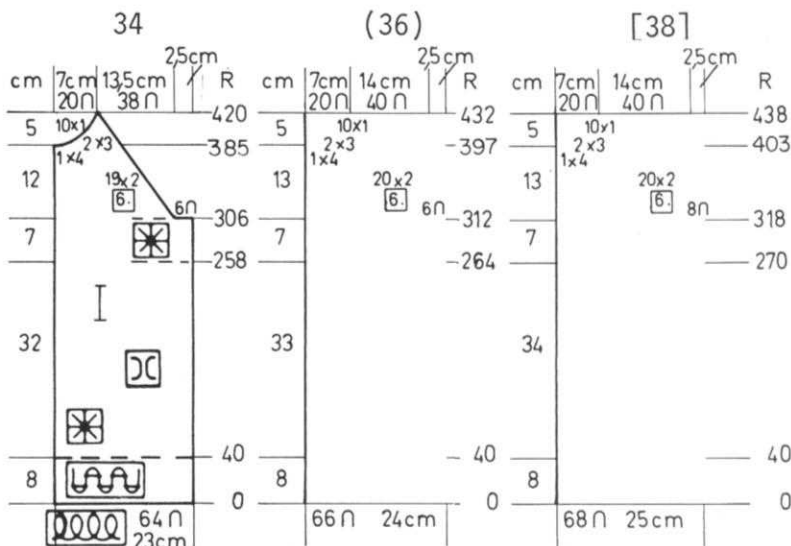
MAN'S JACKET

SIZES: 34 (36) [38]
 YARN: Vienna
 GRAMS: 700 700 750
 TENSION: 5 to 7
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 34 rows = 5 cm (2")

English Rib and Racking Pattern of English Rib (2 pitch swing) See your Ribber Instruction Manual. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Weave seams together from the right side, 1 st. in from edge. Lightly steam Collar and open sts., then sew to garment. Sew in a Jacket type Zipper, 1 st. in from edge.

NOTE: Work Full Fashion Decreases - move 3 edge sts. over 1 needle ON EACH BED (2 st. decrease).

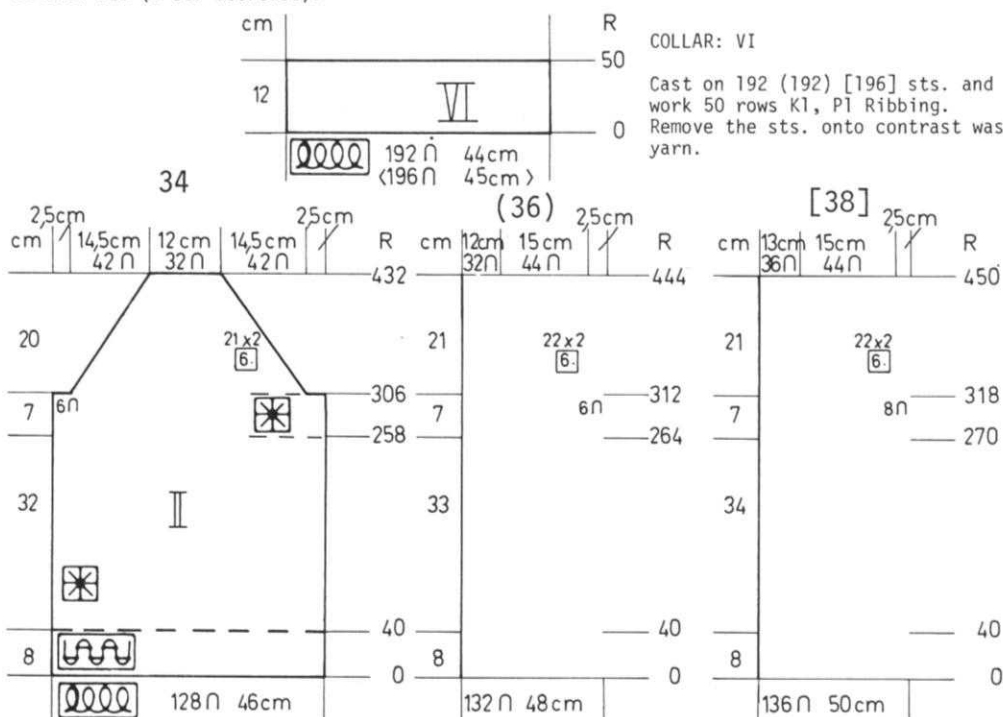


FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 64 (66) [68] sts. and work 40 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in English Rib Pattern to Row 258 (264) [270], then work the Racking Pattern to Row 306 (312) [318]. Continue English Rib. SHAPE RAGLAN: On Arm side, bind off 6 (6) [8] sts. then decrease 2 sts. every 6th row 19x (20x) [20x], but AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 385 (397) [403], SHAPE NECK: Bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 10x for all sizes.

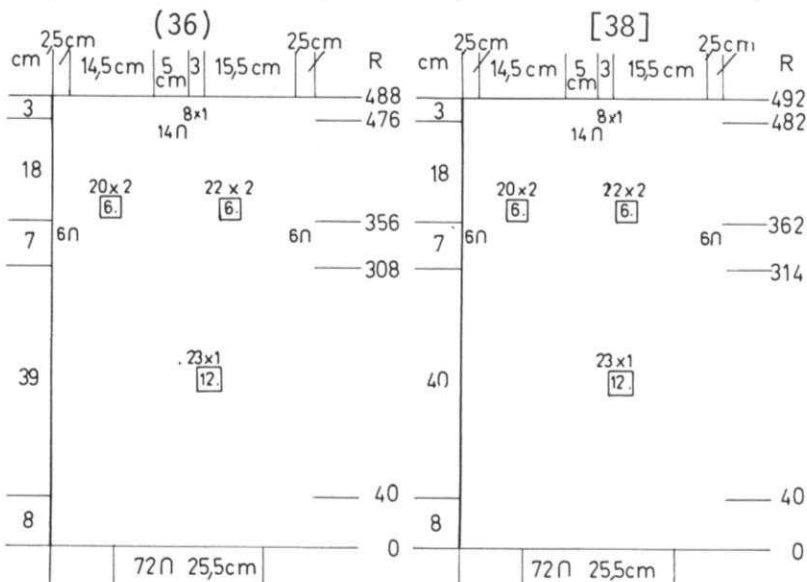
COLLAR: VI

Cast on 192 (192) [196] sts. and work 50 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.



BACK: II

Cast on 128 (132) [136] sts. and work 40 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in English Rib Pattern to Row 258 (264) [270] then change to the Racking Pattern to Row 306 (312) [318]. Change back to the English Rib Pattern and SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 (6) [8] sts. then decrease 2 sts. every 6th row 21x (22x) [22x]. After Row 432 (444) [450], bind off the remaining sts.



SLEEVES: III Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 68 (72) [72] sts. and work 40 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in English Rib Pattern and ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 12th row 23x for all sizes. After Row 308 (308) [314], work the Racking Pattern to Row 356 (356) [362]. Continue in the English Rib Pattern and SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. for all sizes, then decrease 2 sts. every 6th on RIGHT 21x (22x) [22x] and on the LEFT 19x (20x) [20x] and after Row 469 (475) [481], on the LEFT, bind off 14 sts. then decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 8x for all sizes. REVERSE the SHAPING for 2nd sleeve.

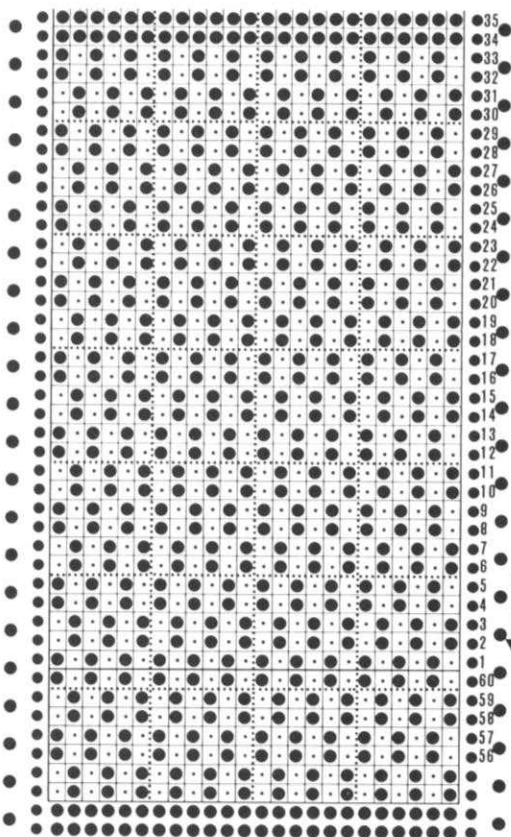
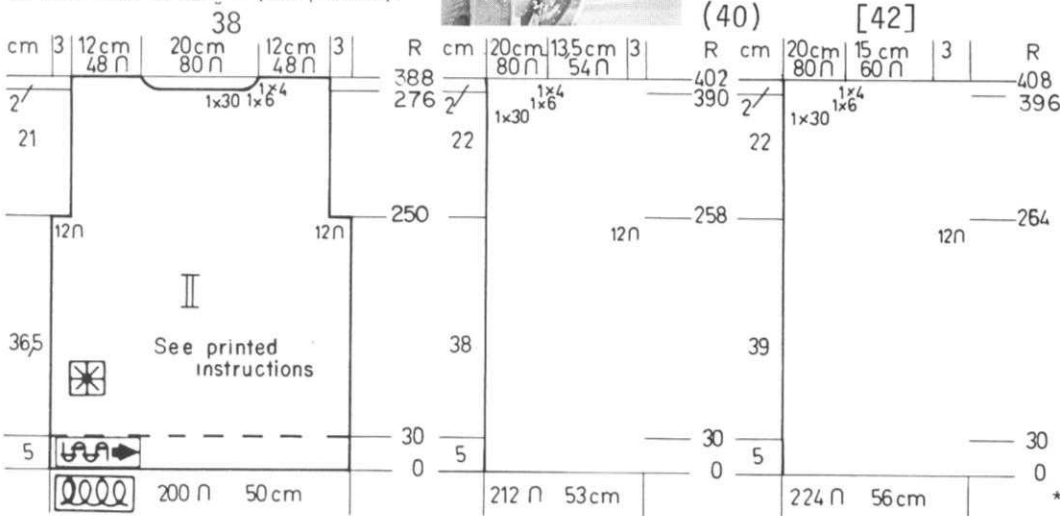
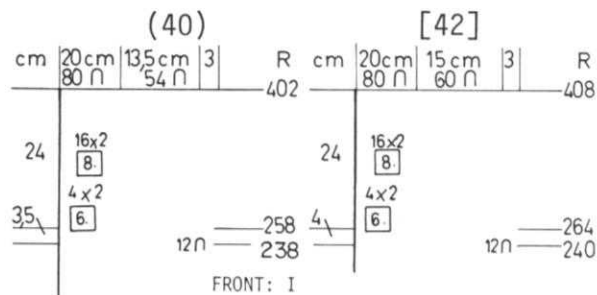
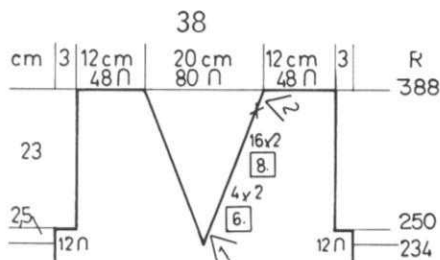

MAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 38 (40) [42]
 YARN: KNITTING Acrylite
 GRAMS: Approx. 20 oz.
 TENSION: 2/2 for K1, P1 Ribbing
 4/4 for Pattern Stitch
 GAUGE: 20 sts. 30 rows = 5 cm (2") Pat.
 27 sts. 24 rows = 5 cm (2") Rib.

A Tuck Stitch using the Main Machine & Ribber. EVERY NEEDLE ON BOTH BEDS.
 Punch Your own Card.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.
 Sew on back Neckband, making sure the band starts where X is on front neck and ends at same place on other side of neck. Baste front insert to V then weave together, leaving 76 sts. free to hang - (see picture).



Work the front the same as the back to Row 234 (238) [240].
 Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*AT NECK EDGE, decrease 2 sts. every 6th row 4x, every 8th row 16x - for all sizes.

AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 250 (258) [264], bind off 12 sts. for Armhole.

After Row 388 (402) [408], bind off the remaining sts.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 234 (238) [240] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

BACK: II

Cast on 200 (212) [224] sts. with half the sts. on the main machine and half on the Ribber. (100) [106] [112] sts. on each bed.

Work 30 rows K1, P1 Ribbing, then continue in Pattern.

Knit to Row 250 (258) [264].

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 12 sts.

Knit to Row 276 (390) [396].

Put half the sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off for all sizes, 30 sts. 1x, 6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x. After Row 388 (402) [408], bind off the remaining sts.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 276 (390) [396] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 112 (112) [120] sts.

56 (56) [60] st. on each bed.

Work 36 rows K1, P1 Ribbing

then continue in Pattern.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st.

every 7th row 36x for all sizes.

After Row 318 (318) [324], bind off.

NECKBAND:

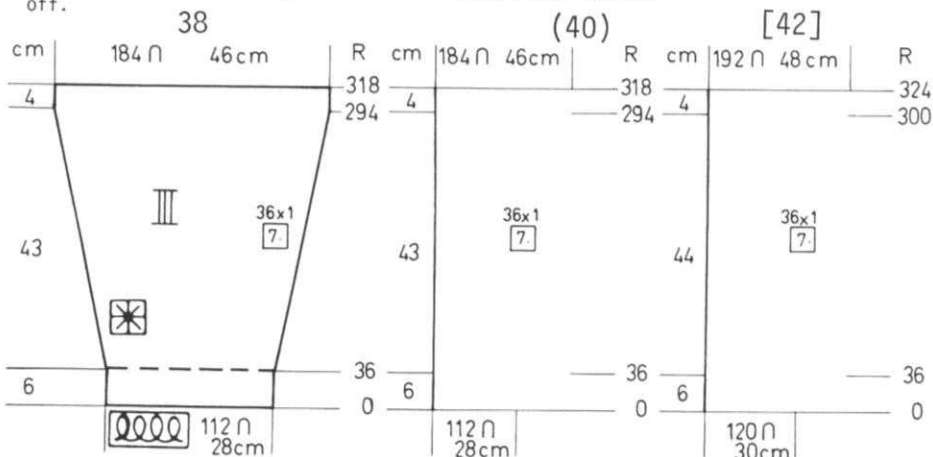
Cast on 220 sts. (110 on main machine, 110 on Ribber).

Tension 6/6 - 12 rows K1, P1

Ribbing with the last 3 rows with

Tension 10. Bind off using the

Latch Tool method.



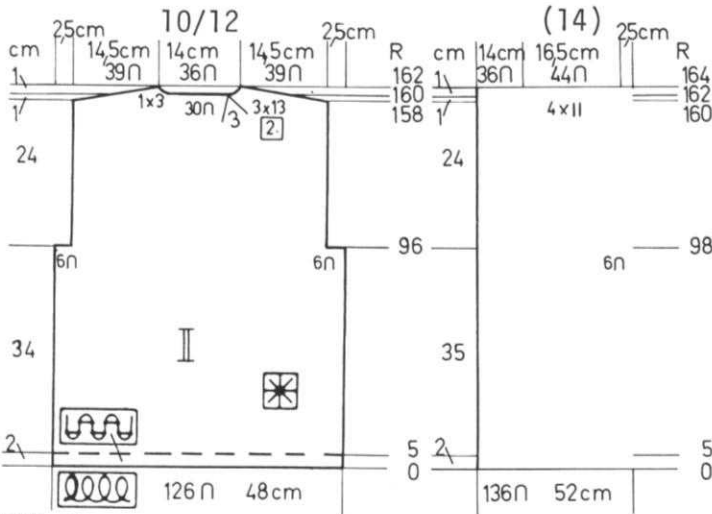

WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 10/12 (14)
YARN: Fortissima or Vienna
GRAMS:
 color 1 350 400
 color 2 100 100
 color 3 50 50
 color 4 50 50
TENSION: 5 to 6
GAUGE: 13 sts. 13 1/2 rows = 5 cm (2")

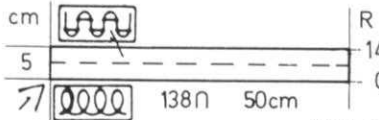
FINISHING: See General Instructions. Close Shoulder. Sew on Armbands and fold over to the inside. Sleeve is attached to the inside, leaving the Ribbing on top (see Picture). Sew bands and collar together then sew to neckline with 76 sts. on back and 76 sts. on each front opening with 32 sts. along straight edge. Sew band to the 10 bind off sts. at center with right over left.

A Norwegian Design on front, back and lower sleeves. Collar & Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.



Cast on 126 (136) sts. and work 5 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Pattern. Knit to Row 96 (98). **SHAPE ARMHOLE:** ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. for both sizes. Knit to Row 158 (160). **SHAPE SHOULDER and WATCH FOR NECK SHAPING.** FOR SHOULDER, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 13 sts. 3x, (11 sts. 4x), FOR NECK, after Row 160 (162), bind off the center 30 sts.

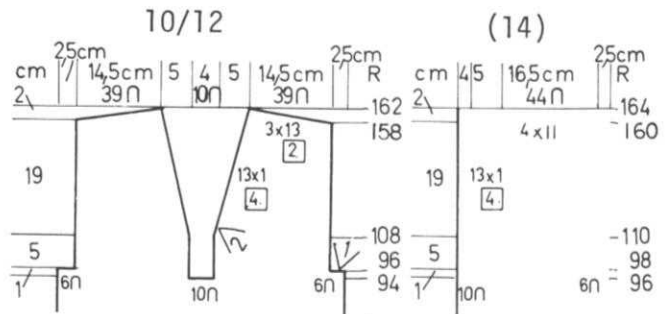
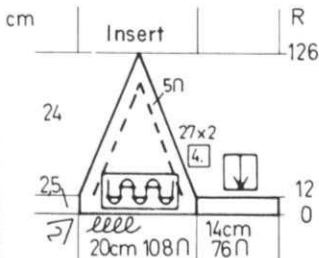
Put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. ***ON NECK SIDE,** bind off 3 sts. 1x, for both sizes. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 160 (162) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.



Cast on 138 sts. and work 14 rows Ribbing then bind off.

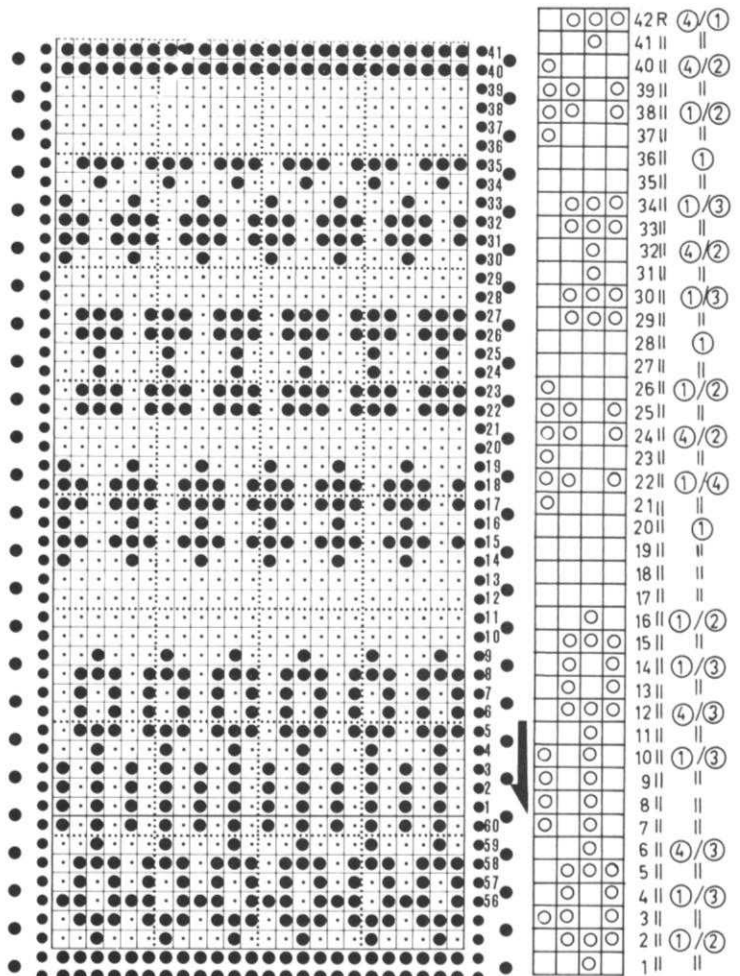
INSERT

Cast on 184 sts. (92 sts. on each bed). Work 12 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. **ON THE RIGHT,** bind off 76 sts. Then continue with Knit/Knit on both beds over the remaining 108 sts. **ON EVERY 4th ROW, ON EACH SIDE,** decrease 2 sts. 27x as follows: Hang the 2nd st. from Ribber, over 1 st., the 3rd st. from Machine over 1 st. The decreases will be on the 5th st. from edge. Insert should be completed after Row 126.

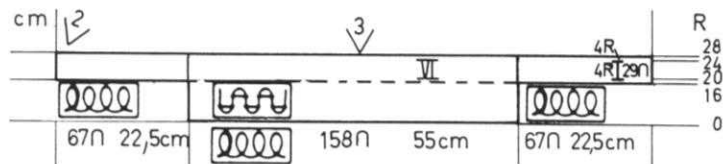
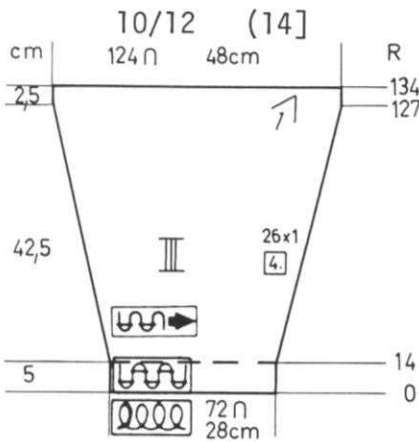


Work the front the same as the back to Row 94 (96). Bind off the center 10 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

***After Row 96 (98),** bind off 6 sts. for armhole. After Row 108 (110), **ON NECK SIDE,** decrease 1 st. every 4th row 13x for both sizes and after Row 158 (160) **SHAPE SHOULDER** same as the back. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 94 (96) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

COLLAR & NECKBAND:

Cast on 158 sts and work 28 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off.

NECKBAND: Cast on 67 sts. Work 12 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off. Work a 2nd band in the same way, but make a BUTTONHOLE after Row 4, working 4 rows over 29 sts. on the right first, then 4 rows over the remaining sts. Bring all needles into work and complete the remaining 4 rows. Bind off. Make another band the same. Sew each piece to each side of Collar. See Picture.

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 72 sts. and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch to Row 30 - but AT THE SAME TIME, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 26x. After Row 30, Continue in Pattern After Row 134, bind off.



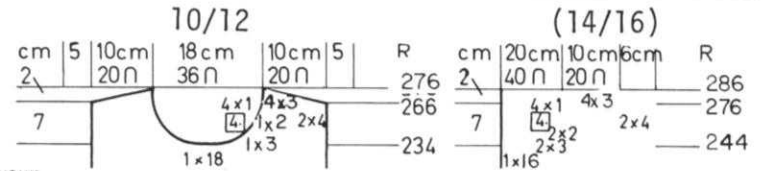

WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 10/12 (14/16)
YARN: Micaela
GRAMS: 350 400
TENSION: 7 or 8
GAUGE: 10 sts. 23 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Tuck Stitch Pattern. Punch your own Card. The bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Crochet around edges of Scarf.



FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 234.

Bind off the center 18 (16) sts. put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, then every 4th row 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, then every 4th row 1 st. 4x). After Row 266 (276), SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 234 (244) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

NECKBAND:

Cast on 144 sts. and work 8 rows Ribbing. Remove onto contrast waste yarn.

SCARF:

Cast on 49 sts. and work in Pattern for 660 rows (55 inches). Bind off.

BACK: II

Cast on 96 (104) sts. and work 36 rows Ribbing.

Continue in Pattern. Knit to Row 164 (174).

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 10 (12) sts.

Knit to Row 266 (276)

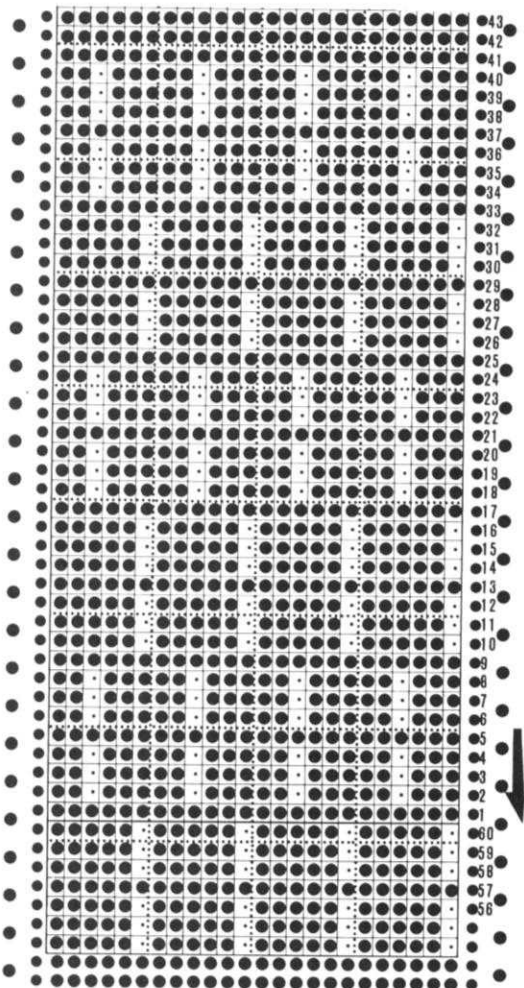
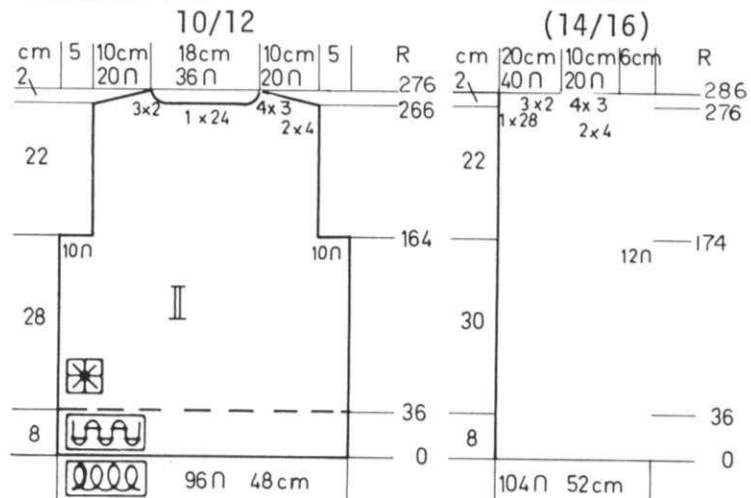
Bind off the center 24 (28) sts. put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

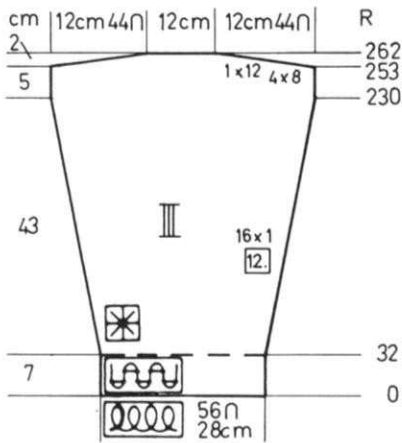
*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off

4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 4x for both sizes. FOR NECK, bind off 2 sts. 3x.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 266 (276) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.





SLEEVES: III

Cast on 56 sts. and work 32 rows Ribbing.
Continue in Pattern and ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 12th row 16x.
After Row 252, SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 4x, 12 sts. 1x.
After Row 262, bind off the remaining sts.

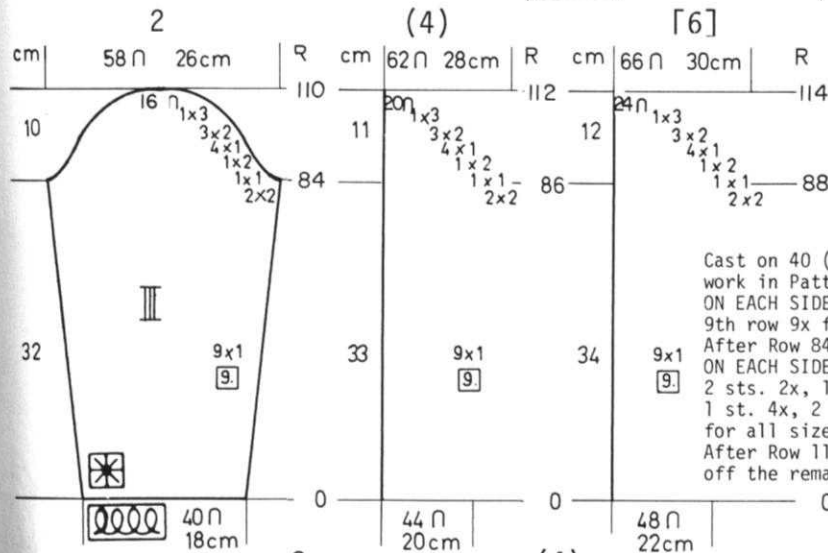
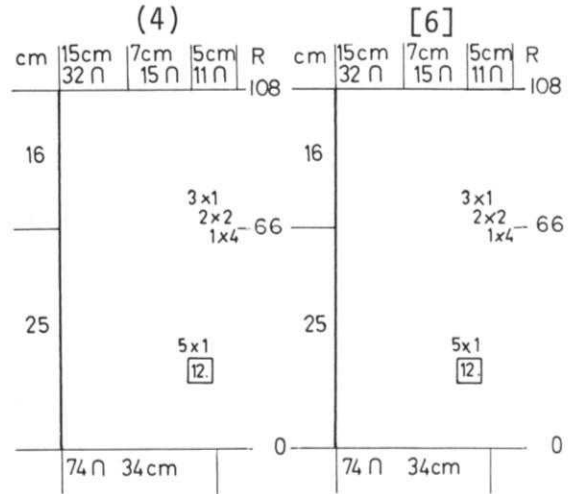
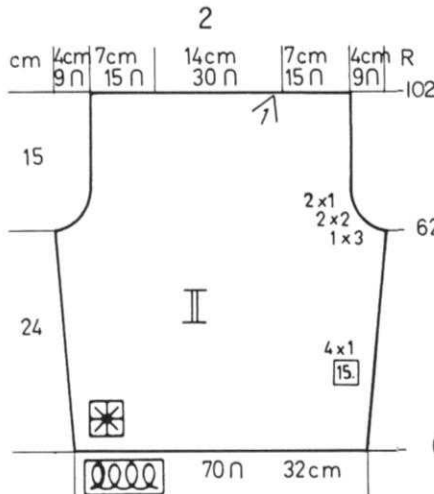
CHILD'S JACKET

SIZES: 2 (4) [6]
YARN: Euro Sport plus thin yarn in another color worked together.
GRAMS: 300 300 350
TENSION: 9 or 10
GAUGE: 11 sts. 13 rows = 5 cm (2")

Knit 1, Purl 1 Ribbing using EVERY 3rd NEEDLE ON EACH BED. Work CABLES after Every 6th row on the Main Machine only. Hang the 1st st. on 2nd, the 3rd on 4th, etc.

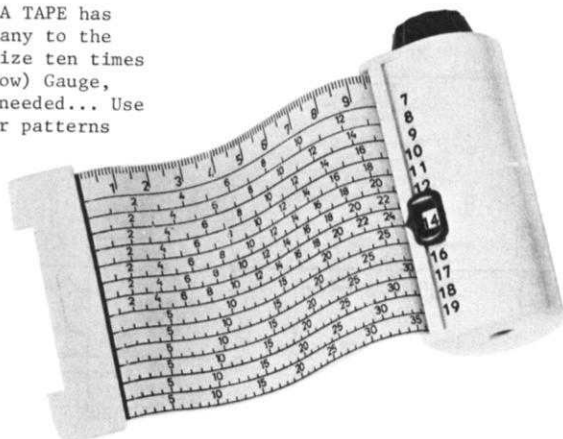
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KNITTING NEWS

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

TO USE THE KNITLEADER WITH THE JUMBO CN-9N KNITTER

You must ALWAYS make a sample swatch FIRST using the yarn, tension number and Stockinette stitch or Pattern Stitch that you will use for knitting your garment.

Cast on 40 sts. with contrast waste yarn. Knit 8 to 10 rows Stockinette stitch. Change to the yarn and Pattern you will use for your garment (Stockinette stitch or Pattern Stitch). Knit 15 rows. Mark the 11th stitch ON EACH SIDE of 0 with a bit of contrast waste yarn (tie it into the stitch). Knit 15 rows. Knit 8 to 10 rows with contrast waste yarn and remove the work from the machine by running the carriage across without yarn.

With your KNITLEADER RULER, measure the sts. (20) between the marked stitches on your swatch. Take the Numbered Strip for your JUMBO KNITTER that is CLOSEST to the measurement... for instance, the 20 stitches might measure 11 cm... so you would use the Number 11.1 Strip... Put it on the machine, centering the 0 on the Strip with 0 on the machine.

To double check your stitch gauge, use your sample swatch and place it on the chosen strip beginning at 0 and the 20 marked stitches in the center of swatch should measure from 0 to 20 on the Strip.

Measure the 30 rows between the waste knitting. Set the ROW REGULATOR to the centimeters and millimeters measurement of the 30 rows (USING YOUR KNITLEADER RULER). For instance, the measurement might be 10 cm (centimeters) and 5 mm (millimeters).

Set BOTH ROW COUNTER TRIPS TO WORKING - so that the Plastic Sheet will MOVE TWICE for EVERY ROW.

Now you are ready to knit your garment, following the shapings which you have drawn on your Knit-leader Sheet.

CLOSED CAST ON

You can make a closed cast-on without using waste knitting by making use of your Cast-on Comb. This is the way it is done.

Hang the Cast-on Comb onto the machine then bring the required number of needles into holding position. Cast on over the shanks of the needles by winding the yarn as though you were forming an 'e' - from left to right. As you are casting on, be sure the stitches are pushed up close to the machine against the gate pegs.

Turn the tension down 1 or 2 numbers and knit 1 row from right to left. Drop the Cast-on Comb and turn the tension to garment tension then continue with your knitting. Hang weights onto the Cast-on Comb to hold the knitting down.

SEWING ZIPPERS INTO A GARMENT

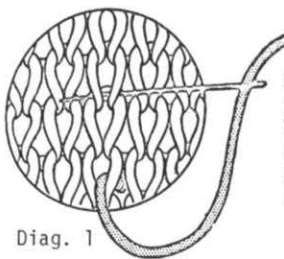
A Jacket type zipper needs to have a firm base for sewing the zipper to garment. Work 1 row of single crochet from the WRONG side of garment, going into every other stitch and keeping the work flat and

even. If you are working REVERSE single crochet at the edge, work one row single crochet from WRONG side then turn the garment to the right side and work reverse single crochet from LEFT to RIGHT.

Pin the zipper in place, easing the knitting to fit. With matching thread, and working on the right side, back stitch the zipper in place.

DUPLICATE STITCH

To work duplicate stitch as shown for DK 801 in this issue of KNITTING MAGAZINE, follow the instructions and diagrams as given below.



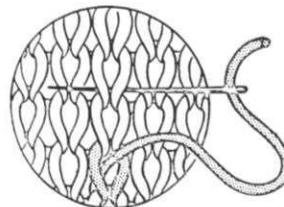
Diag. 1

Work from bottom to top. Bring needle through center of st. from WRONG SIDE of work to RIGHT side. Insert needle from right to left under the two strands of next st. (Diag. 1). Draw yarn through.

Insert needle back into same st. where needle was brought out of beginning (Diag. 2). *Bring needle up through center of st. just completed.

Insert needle from right to left under the two strands of next st. (Diag. 3). Draw yarn through. Insert needle back into same st. where needle was brought out.
