



## General Instructions

#### HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows 5x1

 $\boxed{6}$  The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5xl above the box means - l st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease l st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

#### THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts . Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this... Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size. Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size. Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 2 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section – so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

#### FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move

the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and

hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew l edge to the inside and l to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew l edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

#### THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to O. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to O and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to O and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.



Knit 8 rows, then cross 3 sts. over 3 sts. Drop 1 st. each side of Cable and latch the sts. up into a knit stitch.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Work 1 row single crochet around collar and front edges, then put in zipper. (Use color 1).



Cast on 124 (130) [136] sts. with color 1 and work 12 rows Stockinette stitch. Continue in Weaving Pattern using double yarn for the weaving. Knit to Row 124 (130) [134].

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x]. Knit to Row 196 (204) [208].

SHAPE SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 1x. (6 sts. 4x, 7 sts. 1x). [7 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 1x]. After Row 208 (216) [220], bind off the remaining sts.

[4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x] ON ARM EDGE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 3x. After Row 174 (182) [186], put 52 (55) [58] sts. on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. \*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x. (6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x). 1x, 3 sts. 2x, [6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x]. After Row 208 (216) [220], bind off the remaining sts. Bring the needles on the left into working position and knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 174 (182) [186] and work the left half.





#### PUNCH CARD ON PAGE 40

FINISHING: See General Instructions. JACKET: Sew braid trim on sleeves. Work 2 rows single crochet around edges. Sew collar together and sew in place (see picture). On each side of front, sew on 4 buttons spaced approximately 5 cm (2") apart. SKIRT: Make pleat over the center front of skirt and sew in place. With purl side facing you, hang 34 sts. of the pocket onto machine and with color 1, work 14 rows stockinette stitch AND AT THE SAME TIME, ON EVERY 2nd ROW, decrease 1 st. on inside edge and increase 1 st. on outside edge. After Row 14, bind off. Sew 2 darts on the skirt back. Finish waistline of skirt with 2 rows single crochet then sew on an elastic band and turn to the wrong side - or you can leave the left side open and sew belting to the inside then close with hooks and eyes.



SKIRT FRONT:

Make 2 Pocket Linings first. Cast on 28 sts. with color 1. Work 20 rows Stockinette stitch. Work 42 rows in Pattern. Remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

For Skirt, cast on 192 (198) [198] sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. Continue in Pattern. After Row 36, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 12th row 16x. (every 14th row 15x). [every 15th row 14x]. AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 168, remove the center 58 sts. onto waste yarn (or you can bind off if you prefer). Move the remaining sts. together and continue in pattern. Continue the side decreases. After Row 190, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 1 st. 4x, then 2 sts. 12x for all sizes. Hang the POCKET LINING STS. onto the 28 needles ON EACH SIDE that you just bound off and continue in Pattern. After Row 244, bind off the remaining stitches. See FINISHING for pocket





After Row 188 (190) [196], bind off the remaining sts.





After Row 24, ON SIDE EDGE. decrease 1 st. every 6th row 2x. After Row 54 (58) [58], ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 3x. After Row 96 (102) [106], SHAPE FRONT EDGE and WATCH FOR ARMHOLE SHAPING. FOR FRONT EDGE, increase 1 st. every 2nd row 2x, every 4th row 14x for all sizes and AFTER ROW 101 (107) [111], SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). After Row 146 (154) [158], SHAPE NECK: Bind off (and watch for NECK: Bind off (and watch for SHOULDER SHAPING) for neck -2 sts. 2x, 6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x for all sizes. AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 157 (165) [169] SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off 5 sts. 4x, 6 sts. 1x. (7 sts. 4x) [6 sts. 5x].

BRAID TRIM FOR SLEEVES. Make 2.

Cast on 15 sts. with 3 sts. on the main machine, 1 st. on Ribber, 6 sts. on main machine. 1 st. on Ribber, 3 sts. on main machine.
\*Knit 8 rows, then cross the 6 center sts. 3 and 3 for a Cable. REPEAT from \* for approximately 240 rows. The trim must go down the center of sleeve and across the shoulder.



Cast on 84 sts. with color 1 and work in Pattern.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 2nd row 12x.
After Row 26, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 12x.
After Row 62, bind off.




The Skirt is Stockinette stitch and the front section is knitted in 3 pieces. The Jacket is a tuck stitch combined with Stockinette stitch and is knitted sideways on the machine. The Purl side is the right side. Bands and Collar are Stockinette stitch.

#### PUNCH CARD ON PAGE 40

FINISHING: See General Instructions. SKIRT: Sew darts on front and back sections, using the marked stitches as guide. Turn under 4 cm for waistband then pull elastic through casing. Make hem at lower edge. JACKET: Turn over 4 cm on front edges and sew in place. Make hem at lower edge. Sew 1 edge of Collar to the inside and 1 to the outside of neckline.



Cast on 102 sts. with color 2 and work Stockinette stitch.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 7x.
After Row 42, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 7x.

### PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

### USING LACE PUNCH CARDS

We have had some requests to place markings on the Lace Punch Cards given in KNITKING MAGAZINE, to show the movements of the Lace Carriage and the Knit Carriage (Slide).

The following Instructions for using the Lace Cards which are punched for use with the KH 830 or 820 machines only apply to these machines where the Lace Carriage remains on the machine at all times... it never needs to be lifted and placed to the opposite side of the machine.

If you have worked with any of the Lace Cards in the set which comes with your machine, no doubt you have discovered some interesting facts - the main fact being that before you can knit 2 rows (or more if called for), the Lace Carriage MUST BE ON THE LEFT SIDE and ALL NEEDLES in working position. As long as the Lace Carriage sets needles into Pattern for transferring stitches, you continue to move the Lace Carriage back and forth until the last transfer of stitches and if the Lace Carriage is on the right, there is one more movement to bring the Lace Carriage back to the left. Nothing happens with this last movement, the needles remain just as they are and you can now knit 2 rows with the Knit Carriage.

To help our beginners especially, we will take a look at the Lace Card for KK 713, a Baby Sack and Pullover in this issue of KNITKING MAGAZINE. It is a simple zig-zag eyelet design and you always knit 2 rows after the tranfers and when the Lace Carriage is on the left. We will follow this Card through and see what happens.

Cast on 60 sts. Knit 2 rows (always knit at least 2 rows before beginning a lace pattern). Hang weights on the machine when knitting lace as this prevents dropped stitches. Put in the Punch Card Roll the Card to the No. 1 line and set the Card Put in the Punch Card. on STOP. Move the Lace Carriage from left to right. Needles have set into Pattern. Put the Card on GO. Move the Lace Carriage from right to left. The stitches have been transferred and all needles are in working position. Knit 2 rows with the Knit Carriage. Move the Lace Carriage from Teft to right - the needles set, move the Lace Carriage from right to left. The stitches transfer and the Lace Carriage is again on the left so knit 2 rows with the Knit Carriage. Continue in this manner until the Card shows 16. You have 8 holes in your knitting, all moving to the left. Be sure to knit the 2 rows after the last transfer.

Now the Zig-Zag Pattern must move to the RIGHT. Move the Lace Carriage to the right - nothing happens. Move it to the left. The needles set into pattern. Move the Lace Carriage to the right, the stitches transfer and all needles are in working position - BUT the Lace Carriage is on the right side, so move it back to the left, then knit 2 rows. As you can see, there has to be an EMPTY row so the Lace Carriage can be brought back to the left side. Move the Carriage to the right, nothing happens, move it to the left and the needles set, move it to the right and the stitches transfer, move it back to the left then knit 2 rows.

Continue in this way until the Card shows 60 and you have knitted the 2 rows. You will have 8 holes going to the RIGHT and the pattern now will zig zag to the left. Move the Lace Carriage to the right, the Card shows 1 and the needles are set. Move the Lace Carriage to the left and the stitches transfer to the left. You are now REPEATING THE CARD.

This is the method for working all Lace Cards for the KH 830 or 820 machines. Sometimes you will move the Lace Carriage MANY TIMES before all the needles are back in working position and the Lace Carriage is on the left side. We are giving you only an example for a simple Lace Card.

### DK 670 - WOMAN'S JACKET & SKIRT

We apologize for the omission of the Skirt for DK 670 in our last issue of KNITKING MAGAZINE. The Instructions are printed below with the correct amounts of yarn needed for both the Jacket and Skirt.

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16]
YARN: Micaela
GRAMS: 1100 1150 1200
TENSION: 8.1 for Jacket
5.2 for Skirt

GAUGE: - JACKET: 22 sts. 18 rows = 5 cm (2") SKIRT: 14 sts. 22 rows = 5 cm (2")

SKIRT: - Worn on the Purl side.

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 200 sts. Knit 8 to 10 rows ending with Slide on the right side. Change to garment yarn and put Counter at 0. \*With a single strand of yarn, knit 4 rows. Slide on right. Work SHORT ROWS: ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF SLIDE, put into holding position, 12 sts. Knit 2 rows with SINGLE strand of yarn and be sure to wrap the yarn around the inside needle in holding position.

Knit 2 rows with DOUBLE strand of yarn (be sure to wrap yarn again).

Bring all the needles back into working position and REPEAT from \* 73 x (77x) [81x] more. Row 592 (624) [656]. Remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

Weave the open sts. together then remove the waste yarn. Fold waistband in half to the wrong side and sew in place. Single crochet around lower edge of skirt or you can make a hem if you prefer.


