Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1 4 means decrease (or increase) 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only I set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5xl
[6] The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5xl above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts . Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this... Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size. Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.

Cast on 148 sts. for the 2nd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this... 3 sts. lx (2x) [3x], 2 sts. lx (2x) [3x], l st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section – so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show

above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move

the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then

pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and

hang it onto the empty needle.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.


Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to O. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to O and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")


If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.



Cast on 124 (130) sts. and work



Bind off the center 66 sts. then hang the sts. held on waste yarn onto the machine and continue in Pattern over all the needles. Knit to Row 138.

Divide in the center and complete the right side first.


*SHAPE RAGLAN AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR RAGLAN, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 5x, every 2nd row 31x, (every 4th row 2x, every 2nd row 37x), FOR NECK, decrease 1 st. every 3rd row 28x for both sizes.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, turn the Row Counter back to 138 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



NECKBAND: VIII Make 2.


Cast on 104 sts. and work 20 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 10/12 (14/16) YARN: Euro Sport GRAMS: 750 800 TENSION: 10 A Cable Design with bands and collar K1, P1 Ribbing. You will set up the needles with 4 sts. on the main machine and 1 on the Ribber - across the needle bed. After Every 10 rows, use two double transfer tools and remove 2 sts. on each tool, twist the stitches and hang them back onto the machine. The Cable Design is on the front section and the center of sleeves. The back is Stockinette stitch.




FINISHING: See General Instructions.



SLEEVES: III Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 69 sts. and work 24 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
Continue in Pattern.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st.
every 6th row 16x.
Knit to Row 136.
SHAPE RAGLAN:
ON FRONT SIDE of raglan, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 40x (42x) and on BACK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 42x (44x).
After Row 218 (220), bind off 7 sts. 1x, 6 sts. 2x for both sizes.
REVERSE the shapings for 2nd Sleeve.




POCKET BANDS: Make 2.

Cast on 48 sts. and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

FRONT:

BE SURE TO READ THE INSTRUCTIONS FOR CABLE as given above the FINISHING: Cast on 125 (131) sts. and work 30 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with Cable Design as shown on the Line Drawing, leaving 39 sts. in the center on the main machine with the Cable Pattern set up on each side. After Row 44, ON EACH SIDE, remove 16 (19) sts. onto waste yarn (or you can put them in holding but you must transfer the Ribber sts. to main machine first. ON EACH SIDE of the 93 sts., decrease 2 sts. every 2nd row 6x, 1 st. 15x. After Row 84, remove these 39 sts. onto waste yarn. With garment yarn cast on over the 93 empty needles (closed cast on). Counter at 30. Knit 14 rows, then rehang the 16 sts. held on waste yarn onto the machine. Set the Pattern on each side of the center 93 sts. Knit to Row 84. Bind off the center 39 sts. then hang the sts. held on waste yarn onto the machine and set in Pattern across. Knit to Row 134 (138). SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, on every 2nd row, decrease 2 sts. 6x (6x) 1 st. 29x (31x). AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 186 (190) Bind off the center 15 (15) sts. put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x (5x). Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit I row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 186 (190) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the raglan shaping.





The Overalls are Stockinette stitch with a Norwegian Border Design on front Bib. The Pullover is a Norwegian Design. Leg Bands and Pullover lower edge are in Stockinette stitch.

FINISHING: Pullover: Weave shoulder & sleeve seams and sew sides together. Work 1 row single crochet and 1 row reverse single crochet around front and neck edges and AT THE SAME TIME on front diagonal shaping crochet 4 small buttonholes. Work the same crochet around sleeves. OVERALLS: Sew fabric strips to sides of front and back sections then put in gripper snaps. Work the same crochet edging as on Pullover around the bib section after sewing it in place. Crochet around straps making loop for buttonhole and sew buttons to front of bib (see picture).

With color 2, work Shell stitch -*7 double crochet in 2nd st., 1 single crochet in next st., skip 1 sc, then REPEAT FROM Work 2 rows single crochet with color 1 around neckline then with color 2, work the same shell stitch as for leg and sleeve edges.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

KK 639 - MAKE SOME CAST ON STRIPS

An OPEN CAST ON for the Sleeves on this Baby Pullover can be easier for you if you make the cast on pieces separately and then just hang them onto the machine at the underarm where you need to cast on 40 sts. In fact, this method can be used in many other places and is especially great when you are working in a Pattern. Since you will need 4 strips for this little garment, why not make up the 4 separate strips and SAVE THEM for future use - and you WILL use them.

It is important that you use a similar weight yarn for your strips. Some people make strips in varous weights and you can do the same. If you have a few strips made from a light weight yarn, a medium weight yarn and a heavier weight yarn, you are ready for open cast on's for use with any weight garment.

If you have some AMORE left overs in different colors, use this yarn for your strips as it is an excellent twisted yarn which can be washed and will not split because of its twist.

Now you are ready to make 4 strips. USE CLOSED CAST ON for cast on strips. With a light color Amore, cast on 50 sts. (We will use 50 sts. although you really only need 40) because we want to use the strips for other garments and 50 is a good number. Use Tension 7 or 8. Knit 6 rows then mark the tension by transferring 7 or 8 sts. to the next needle and leave the empty needles in work. Knit 6 more rows. With a bright contrast color yarn, knit 1 row. Change back to the original yarn and knit 12 rows. Bind off. Press the strip and secure all ends. Make 3 more strips the same.

You can now knit the little Pullover and when you reach Row 78 for the back, bring 40 needles ON EACH SIDE into working position for the sleeves and hang a cast on strip onto each side. Fold the strip with the purl side out so you can see the row of contrast sts. and hang 40 of them onto the machine needles. Knit I row over the newly cast on sts. using a piece of Ravel Cord (you can always use some rayon crochet thread if you do not have odd pieces of Ravel Cord). You are now ready to continue knitting but remember it is always a good idea to knit the first row over the newly cast on sts. in Stockinette stitch. makes it easier for you to weave the open sts. together later on. When you have completed the garment and have woven the underarm seam, release the Ravel Cords at each end then pull them out... You still have your cast on strips for future use and they can be used ANYWHERE on a garment that calls for an OPEN CAST ON...
