All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

-  Increase
-  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
-  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.

-  Pattern Stitch
-  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Knit side.
-  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Purl side.





-  Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.

REPEAT the above for each complete row.

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as (12/14) and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1
[6] The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...

3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITTING machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS:

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box (or Slide) are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the Trip Control Lever so that only 1 row registers.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITTING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even overnight. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn - Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will shown in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

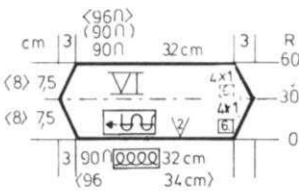
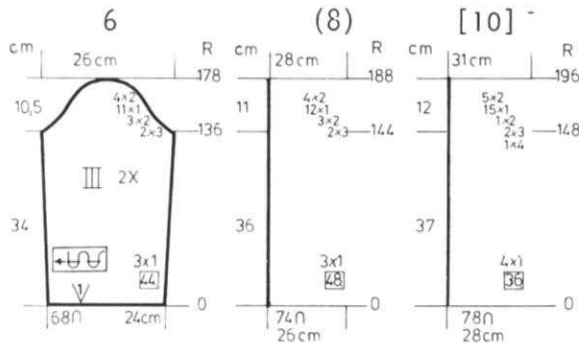

Jacket is Stockinette stitch worn on the Purl side. Skirt is Stockinette stitch with color stripes. Worn on the Purl side.

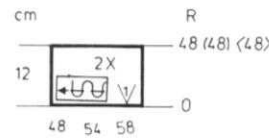
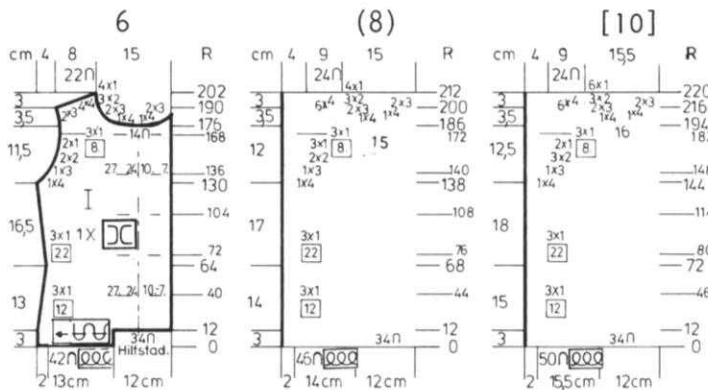
FINISHING: Skirt: Weave the open sts. together then remove waste yarn. Fold pleats and baste in place. Sew one edge of waistband to inside and one to outside. Thread elastic through casing.

JACKET: See General Instructions. Fold facing and weave the open sts. then remove the waste yarn. Finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.



COLLAR:

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 90 (90) [96] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to garment yarn and put Counter at 0. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 6th row 4x. After Row 30 (30) [34], ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 4x. After Row 60 (60) [68], bind off loosely.



CUFFS:

Hang the open sts. of the sleeve back onto the machine, decreasing to 48 (54) [58] sts. Remove the waste yarn. Work Stockinette stitch to Row 48 then bind off.

SLEEVES: III

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 68 (74) [78] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, change to garment yarn and put Counter at 0. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 44th row 3x. (every 48th row 3x). [every 36th row 4x]. Knit to Row 136 (144) [148]. SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 11x, 2 sts. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 12x, 2 sts. 4x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 15x, 2 sts. 5x]. After Row 178 (188) [196], bind off the remaining sts.

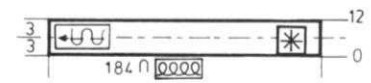
FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 42 (46) [50] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. After Row 12, with waste yarn, cast on 34 sts. Continue with garment yarn over all the sts. ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 12th row 3x and after Row 40 (44) [46], make BUTTONHOLES over needles 7 to 10 and 24 to 27, counting from the right edge. Make the following Buttonholes over the same needles after the rows shown on the Chart for YOUR SIZE. After Row 64 (68) [72], ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 22nd row 3x. Knit to Row 131 (139) [145]. SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 2x then increase 1 st. every 8th row 3x. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x, then increase 1 st. every 8th row 3x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x, then increase 1 st. every 8th row 3x]. AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 176 (186) [194], leave 10 sts. on the right in holding position, bind off the next 14 (15) [16] sts., put the remaining sts. into holding position. Push the 10 sts. on the right (left for 2nd section into working position and on NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x. Bring the needles on the left (right) into working position, turn the Row Counter back to 176 (186) [194] and ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x, and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 191. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 201). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x and SHAPE SHOULDER SAME as the back after Row 209]. Work the 2nd section with reverse shaping, casting on from right to left. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0. Omit the buttonholes.

JACKET BACK: II

Cast on 100 (106) [112] sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. After Row 12, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 16th row 3x. Knit to Row 64 (68) [72]. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 22nd row 3x. Knit to Row 130 (138) [144]. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x]. Knit to Row 190 (200) [208]. SHAPE SHOULDER and watch for neck shaping. FOR SHOULDER, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 4x. (4 sts. 6x) [4 sts. 6x]. SHAPE NECK after Row 198 (208) [216]. Bind off the center 24 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. ON NECK SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 1x. (6 sts. 1x). [8 sts. 1x]. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 198 (208) [216] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.

WAISTBAND:

Cast on 184 sts. with color 1 and work 12 rows of 2 rows color 1, 2 rows color 2, 4 rows color 3, 2 rows color 2, 2 rows color 1. Bind off loosely.

SKIRT:

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 178 (184) [190] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1 and put Counter at 0. Continue in Stockinette stitch with REPEATED color stripes as given below, but AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 12 and every following 44th row, knit 1 row with a DOUBLE STRAND OF YARN and after Row 24, and every following 44th row, mark each side with a small piece of contrast yarn (for the UNDER pleat). COLOR STRIPES: 4 rows color 1 2 rows color 2 2 rows color 3 2 rows color 4 2 rows color 1 2 rows color 2 2 rows color 3 REPEAT THE COLOR STRIPES from the beginning. After Row 608 (652) [696], knit 8 to 10 rows with contrast waste yarn and remove the work from the machine.

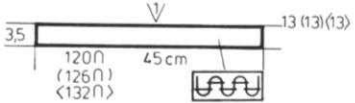


MAN'S PULLOVER & SOCKS

SIZES: 38 (40) [42]
 YARN: Binia
 GRAMS: Pullover 500 550 600
 Socks 150 150 150
 TENSION: 7 to 9
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")

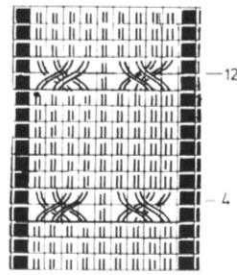
Stockinette stitch with a Cable Design down left front section and center of sleeves and side of Socks. The knit side is the right side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



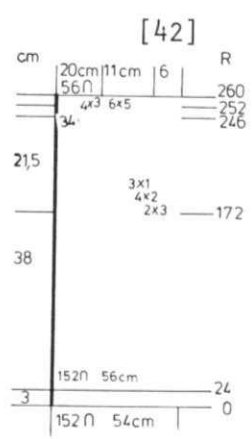
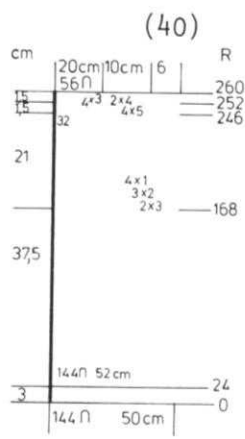
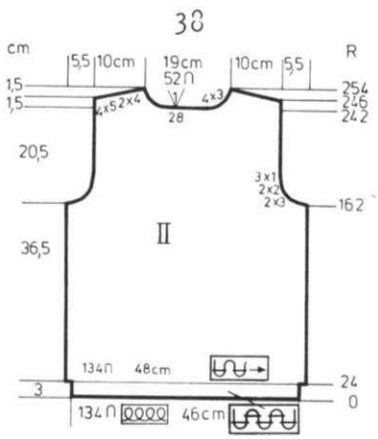
NECKBAND:

Cast on 120 (126) [132] sts. and work 13 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



BACK: II

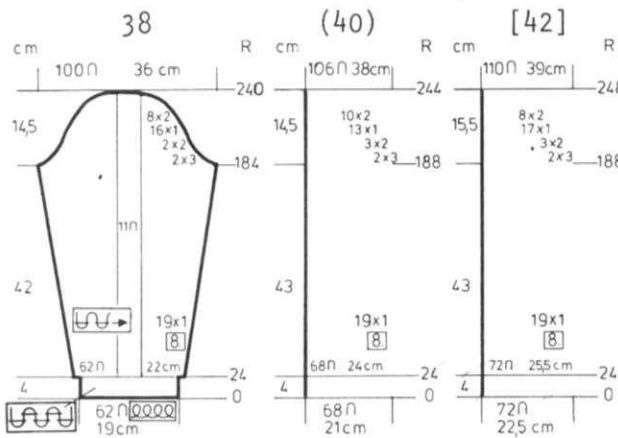
Cast on 134 (144) [152] sts. and work 24 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 162 (168) [172]. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 3x]. Knit to Row 242 (246) [246]. Bind off the center 28 (32) [34] sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 4x and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 246 (252) [252], SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off 5 sts. 4x, 4 sts. 2x. (5 sts. 4x, 4 sts. 2x). [5 sts. 6x]. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 242 (246) [246] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

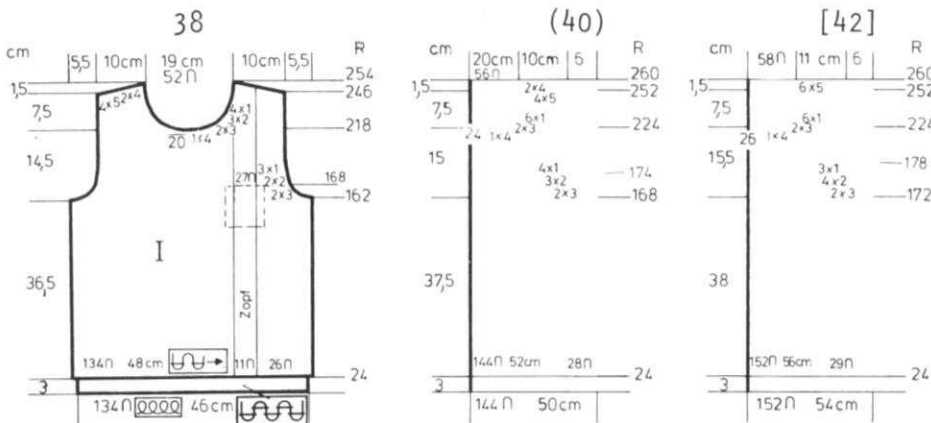

SLEEVES:

Cast on 62 (68) [72] sts. and work 24 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with Cable Design over the center 11 sts. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 19x. After Row 184 (188) [188], SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 16x, 2 sts. 8x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 13x, 2 sts. 10x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 17x, 2 sts. 8x]. After Row 240 (248) [248], bind off the remaining sts.



POCKET LINING:

Cast on 29 sts. and work 34 rows Stockinette stitch then remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

FRONT: II

BE SURE TO COMPLETE THE POCKET LINING FIRST.

Cast on 134 (144) [152] sts. and work 24 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with Cable Design. Follow the Line Drawing and work the Cable Design over needles 27 to 37 counting from the LEFT edge.

Knit to Row 162 (168) [172]. SHAPE ARMHOLE the same as the back but AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 168 (174) [178], remove the 11 sts. of the Cable Design plus 8 sts. ON EACH SIDE of these (27 sts.) onto a stitch holder and immediately hang the open sts. of the Pocket Lining onto these needles, remove the waste yarn and continue the Cable Design over the center 11 needles as before.

Knit to Row 218 (224) [224]. Bind off the center 20 (24) [26] sts. for neck, put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right side first.

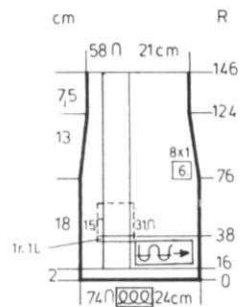
*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 246.

(4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x, and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 252).

[4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 252].

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 218 (224) [224] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

Hang the open sts. of Pocket onto machine, transfer every other stitch to the Ribber and work 8 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



POCKET SOCKS: Make 2.

Cast on 74 sts. and work Stockinette stitch.

Knit to Row 16, then begin the Cable Design over needles 24 to 34 counting from the left edge (11 sts. for Cable Design). Knit to Row 38.

FOR POCKET, remove the 16th to 43rd sts., counting from the left onto a stitch holder, then with contrast waste yarn, cast on over these same needles and continue over all the needles with main yarn working the Cable Design.

After Row 76, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 5x. Knit to Row 145.

ON EACH SIDE, remove 16 sts. onto a stitch holder.

Stop the Cable Design and over the remaining 32 sts. knit 64 rows for the instep then work SHORT ROWS for the toe.

*ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 1 needle before knitting each row until 8 sts. remain in the center.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position 1 needle before knitting each row until all are in work**.

Knit 64 rows for foot, then REPEAT the SHORT ROWS, following the instructions from * to ** for heel. Remove the sts. onto a stitch holder.

With purl side facing you, hang the open sts. of TOP of sock back onto the machine and remove the waste yarn. Knit 34 rows Stockinette stitch then bind off. (lining). With Purl side facing you, hang the open sts. of Pocket onto machine and transfer every other st. to the Ribber and work 6 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

Sew pocket lining in place and sew down Ribbed band. Weave the back leg seam on the very edge, then weave the open sts. of heel to to open sts. of leg and remove waste yarn. Make hem at top of sock and run elastic through casing.

Work the 2nd sock with the Cable Design on the RIGHT and omit pocket.

SHAPE NECK: Bind off 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x, and **SHAPE SHOULDER** same as the back after Row 118. (4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x and **SHAPE SHOULDER** same as the back after Row 122).

[5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x, and **SHAPE SHOULDER** same as the back after Row 128].

ON THE RIGHT (left for 2nd section), increase 1 st. every 6th row 4x, every 4th row 4x. After Row 96 (110) [114], on the RIGHT (left), decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 8x (9x) [9x]. After Row 112 (126) [132], cast on 5 sts. Knit to Row 149 (159) [165]. SHAPE POCKET: Bind off 6 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (8 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [8 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x]. After Row 172 (184) [192], bind off the remaining sts.

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Sew the inside leg seams together, then hang the open sts. of leg onto machine, decreasing to 70 (76) [80] sts. Transfer every other stitch to the Ribber and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Sew peplum to lower edge of jacket. Embroider flowers on front as shown on picture. Work crochet around lower edge of jacket and sleeves and around neckline and front edges.
 ROW 1: With color 1, single crochet.

Lower the tension 1 number and knit 4 rows. Set the needles into Mock Rib (or K1, P1 Ribbing). Knit 30 rows, knit 1 row Tension 10, return to tension you used for first half and knit 30 rows. Bring all the needles into working position and knit 4 rows. Remove the sts. onto waste yarn. Fold in half and sew down to the inside.

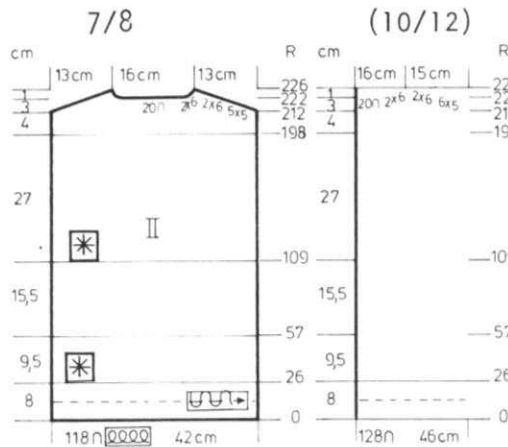


PATTERN II 25 rows colors 1 + 5
3 rows color 1



SLEEVES: III

Bring 59 (68) needles into working position then set into Mock Rib Pattern (or work K1, P1 Ribbing over all the needles for 26 rows. Turn Tension Down and work Mock Rib to Row 52. Hang the hem and continue over all the needles as you did on back & front. Put Row Counter to 26. Work the Norwegian Pattern No I AND AT THE SAME TIME, increase 1 st. every 4th row 32x changing to Stockinette stitch with color 1 when Pattern is completed. After Row 150 (Set Pattern at Row 149) work the Norwegian Pattern No I. After Row 180, bind off.



PULLOVER BACK:

Bring 118 (128) needles into working position then set into MOCK RIB with every 3rd needle out of work. (If you own a Ribber, you can work K1, P1 Ribbing over all the needles for 26 rows). Cast on over the remaining needles in work with color 1. Turn Tension down 1 number and knit 52 rows, then hang the hem. Turn to garment tension, bring empty needles into work and continue over all the needles. Put the Row Counter back to 26 and work the Norwegian Design using Pattern I to Row 57. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1 to Row 110 (set needles for Pattern I after Row 109). Work the Norwegian design Pattern I, then Pattern II, following by Pattern I again. When Pattern is completed, continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1. After Row 212 SHAPE SHOULDER (watch for neck shaping). FOR SHOULDER, bind off 5 sts. 5x, 6 sts. 2x, (5 sts. 6x, 6 sts. 2x), AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 222, SHAPE NECK. Bind off the center 20 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 6 sts. 2x. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 222 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.

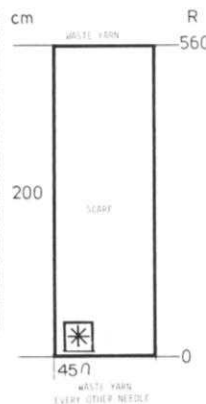

SIZE: WOMAN'S
YARN: Euro Sport
GRAMS:
Color 1 200
Color 2 100
Color 3 100
Color 4 100
TENSION: 10
GAUGE: 9 sts. 12 rows = 5 cm (2")
OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE

Scarf: Norwegian Design (same as DK 448). Cap: Stripes. Knitted OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE.

FINISHING: CAP: Weave the open sts. of back seam together and remove the waste yarn. Sew band seam then fold in half sew down and remove the waste yarn. Gather top of hat then sew on a pom-pom. SCARF: Wind the yarn around a 12" cardboard then cut only 1 edge. Use the 4 colors for each fringe. Fold in half and attach to each end of scarf (see picture).



SCARF: OPEN CAST ON, 45 sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE. Work in the Norwegian Design, repeating PATTERN I & II to Row 560. Remove on waste yarn. Slip stitch the ends of scarf with color 1. Be sure to work loosely. Remove waste yarn.

PANTS FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 45 (53) sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.

Knit to Row 20.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 6x.

Knit to Row 73.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, increase 1 st.

2x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x, then decrease 1 st. every 4th row 3x.

Knit to Row 261. Remove on waste yarn.

Work the 2nd section with reverse shaping, casting on from right to left. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0.

LEG BANDS: Sew side seams first, then hang the open sts. of leg back onto the machine with right side facing you, decreasing to 84 sts.

Knit 12 rows Tension 6.

Knit 1 Row Tension 10.

Knit 13 rows Tension 6.

Remove on waste yarn. Fold under and sew down.

Knit 6 rows Tension 8, 1 row Tension 10, 7 rows Tension 8. Hang the hem Change to garment Tension. Continue in the Norwegian Design REPEATING Pattern I and II. After Row 18, ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 7th row 16x. Knit to Row 132. ON FRONT EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 7th row 12x, (every 8th row 8x, every 7th row 4x), AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 144, ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 5x. After Row 168, SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off 5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 2x. (5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 3x). Knit to Row 208 (214) then SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.

CAP:

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 35 sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE. Knit 8 to 10 rows then change to color 1 and put the Counter at 0.

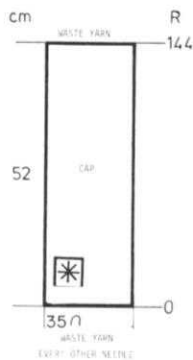
Work Stockinette stitch with REPEATED COLOR STRIPES of

- 2 rows color 1
- 4 rows color 2
- 2 rows color 1
- 4 rows color 4
- 2 rows color 1
- 4 rows color 3
- 2 rows color 1

After Row 144, remove onto contrast waste yarn.

With purl side facing you, hang 1 long edge back onto the machine (EVERY OTHER NEEDLE).

Knit 50 rows Stockinette stitch with color 1. Remove onto waste yarn.



THE PATTERN IS A REPEAT OF 100 ROWS (Using Pattern I and II) as follows.

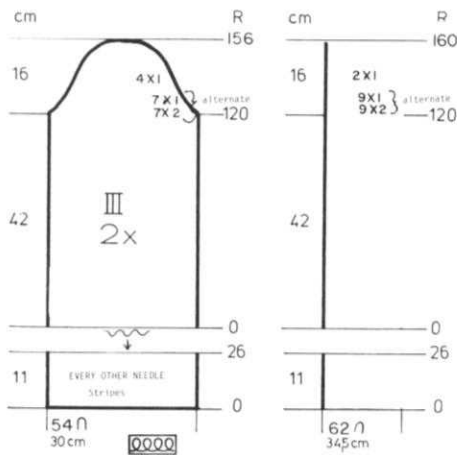

FRONT & NECK BAND:

With color 1, cast on 24 sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE and work Stockinette stitch.
With Tension 8, knit approximately 404 rows then remove on waste yarn so that you may pull out any extra rows if need be.

Cast on 54 (62) sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE with color 1.
Knit REPEATED COLOR STRIPES of 2 rows color 1, 4 rows color 2, 2 rows color 1, 4 rows color 4, 2 rows color 1, 4 rows color 3, 2 rows color 1.
After Row 26, remove the sts. onto waste yarn.
With knit side facing you, hang the sts. back onto the machine. Put Counter at 0 and work Stockinette stitch.
Knit to Row 120.
SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off *2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x and REPEAT from * 6x more (8x more), then ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. 4x (2x).
After Row 156 (160) bind off.

BACK: II

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 90 (96) sts. OVER EVERY OTHER NEEDLE and work Stockinette stitch.

Knit 8 to 10 rows, then change to garment yarn - color 1 and Put Counter at 0.

Knit 6 rows Tension 8, 1 row Tension 10, 7 rows Tension 8. Hang the hem and continue with garment tension and work the NORWEGIAN Design, REPEATING Pattern I and II.

After Row 18, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 7th row 16x. After Row 144, ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 5x.

After Row 168, SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 2x. (5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 3x). Knit to Row 208 (214).

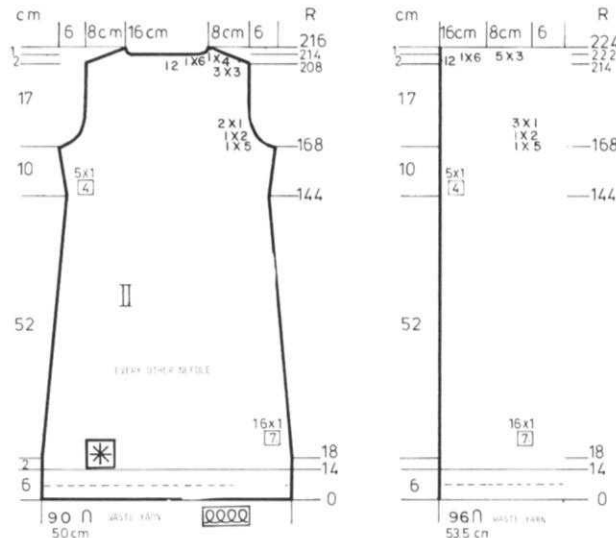
SHAPE SHOULDER and watch for Neck Shaping.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off 3 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 1x. (3 sts. 5x).

FOR NECK: After Row 214 (222) bind off the center 12 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 6 sts. 1x, for all sizes.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 208 (214) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the shoulder shaping.



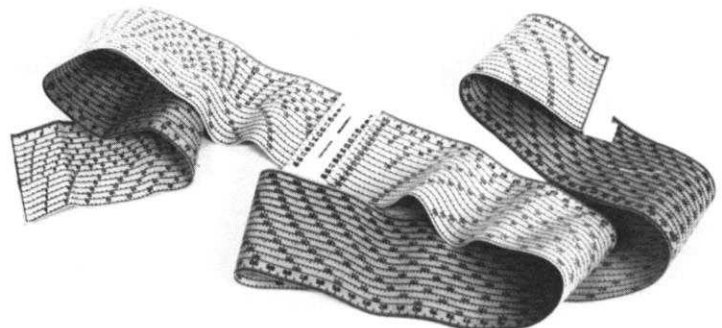

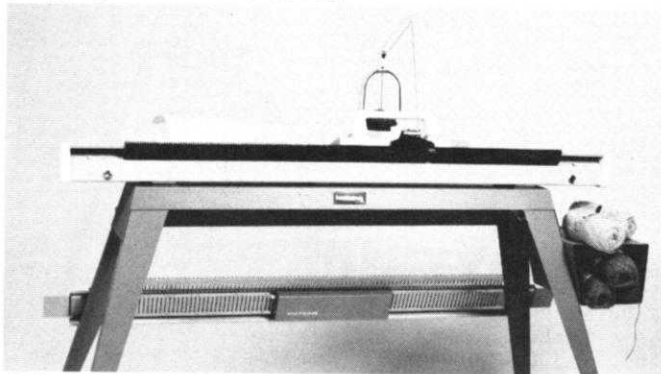

In the last issue, we told you about the new and easy way of assembling and blocking your garments with the use of PIANO WIRES. They proved so popular that we sold out within three weeks of the

You receive three long and three short wires in a package and you can throw away your blocking pins and forget basting threads when you use the PIANO WIRES. PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

LOWER THE TENSION FOR BANDS

No one likes to have a loose or ruffled band on a Pullover or a loose sleeve band. To avoid this, you can change the tensions when knitting a band.

If you are working K1, P1 Ribbing, lower the tension one number for the Ribbing section. If you are working a MOCK RIB or a STOCKINETTE Stitch band, you will need to make more of an adjustment in your tensions so that the band will fit well.

A Mock Rib can be knitted with 2 or even 3 tensions lower. When you hang the hem, be sure the stitches LINE UP and to prevent a hole along the hem line, you must either pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto each empty needle, or pick up the cross thread below the empty needle, give it a twist and hang it onto the empty needle all along the row. Put ALL the stitches behind the latches and knit them together with 2 or even 3 tensions higher than the garment tension, then turn the tension to the correct one for your garment.

A Stockinette stitch band should be made with graduated tensions. For example: If you are knitting a garment with Tension 6, work the band as follows: Let us say the complete band will take 40 rows, 20 of these for the underhem and 20 for the band. Cast on the stitches, then knit 10 rows Tension 5, 9 rows Tension 4, 1 row Tension 8 (for turning row), 9 rows Tension 4, 10 rows Tension 5. Hang the cast on stitches onto the machine, put the stitches BEHIND the latches and knit 1 row Tension 8 (This will be Row 40 - you hung the hem after Row 39). Turn the tension to the garment tension 6 and continue.

It is important that you knit the doubled stitches together with a larger tension after hanging the hem. Before pressing the sections, always take a ruler or a flat rod, run it through the doubled hem and pull downwards. You are now ready to press your section. Do not EVER press K1, P1 Ribbing, but a MOCK RIB should be pressed after pulling it onto shape.
