All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

General Instructions

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS ISSUE

FULL FASHION DECREASING AND INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for decreasing or increasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch, then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang

it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the trip control lever so that only 1 row registers.

TO MAKE FRINGE

Cut yarn DOUBLE the length of fringe desired (wind around a cardboard or book). Using 2 or more strands of yarn (depending on weight of yarn) fold in half and with a crochet hook, draw folded loop through knitting from the wrong side. Pull strands through loop and tighten.

To make an additional row of knots on fringe, take half the strands from 1 group and half from the next group, then knot together approximately 1" to 2" below and continue across.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a Cardigan or Jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 Tension Numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows WITHOUT actually counting, by using our KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast-on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end. knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn, then remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the figuring for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn. Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window ... Easy ..? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.






BACK: II

Cast on 111 (123) [135] sts. and work 28 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to the Holding Position Design. Knit to Row 84. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 30th row 5x. Knit to Row 238. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, on every 4th row, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 4x. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, i st. 4x]. Knit to Row 338 (444) [450]. Bind off the center 21 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 2 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 4x. (3 sts. 7x). [3 sts. 4x, 4 sts. 3x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 338 (444) [450] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 238. SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back then knit to Row 306 (412) [418]. Bind off the center 19 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x, then on EVERY 4th ROW, decrease 1 st. 6x, AND SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 344 (450) [456]. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 306 (412) [418] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



NECKBAND: VIII

Cast on 157 sts. and work 24 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



SLEEVE: III

Cast on 61 (67) [73] sts. and work 28 rows K1, P. Ribbing. Change to the Holding Position Design.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 6x, every 12th row 11x. Knit to Row 244.
SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, on EVERY 4th Row, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 15x, 3 sts. 2x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 18x, 3 sts. 2x). [3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 21x, 3 sts. 1x]. After Row 318 (324) [332], bind off the remaining 11 sts.


Cast on 121 (131) [145] sts. and work 44 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 24th row 7x. Knit to Row 214. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x. 1 st. 3x. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x]. Knit to Row 294 (304) [314]. Bind off the center 35 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 3 sts. 6x. (3 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 3x). [4 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 2x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 2x. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 294 (304) [314] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




COLLAR: VIII Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 125 (131) [137] sts. and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON THE RIGHT side, (left for 2nd section), decrease 2 sts. 13x. After Row 28, bind off the remaining sts. the crochet method for Ribbing.







FRONT: I

Cast on 121 (131) [145] sts. and work 44 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch with Cable Design. Follow the Chart to set up the needle spacing of Pattern and the Line Drawing for the Cable Design with out of work needles. Knit to Row 188. Hang the center stitch on the neighboring needle and put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 14x, every 4th row 21x, AND AT THE SAME TIME, SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back after Row 214 and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 294 (304) [314]. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit I row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 188 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




PATTERN: A Holding Position Design using color 1 and worn on the Purl side.
*Put needles 1, 3, 5, 7 etc. into holding position, knit 1 row. Bring all the needles back into working position, knit 1 row. REPEAT from * for Pattern. KNITKING machine owners, use Wheel No. 6 and push in the RIGHT Retractor Button and leave it there. TRIM: Stockinette stitch using color 2 with the knit side as the right side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions Sew 1 edge of Collar to inside and 1 to the outside of neckline, then with color 2, knit bands for Trim. Cast on 17 sts. with color 2 and with Tension 6 to 8, knit Stockinette stitch. Make the band long enough to go around edges of Collar and Jacket then remove the knitting onto waste yarn so that you can pull out any extra rows. Sew 1 edge to inside and 1 to the outside of Collar and Jacket edges.' Make 2 more strips in the same way to fit around sleeve edges.




BACK: II

Cast on 105 (115) [127] sts. and work in Holding Position Design. After Row 18. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 5x. Knit to Row 78. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 18th row 5x. Knit to Row 166. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 4x]. Knit to Row 244 (254) [262]. Bind off the center 15 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 2 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 7x. (3 sts. 7x, 4 sts. 1x). [3 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 5x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 244 (254) [262] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




SLEEVE: III

Cast on 57 (63) [69] sts. and work 44 rows K1, Pl Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 15x, every 6th row 5x. Knit to Row 194. SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 17x. 2 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 4x. (3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 20x, 2 sts. 2x. 3 sts. 3x). 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 3x). [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 2lx, 2 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 3x]. After Row 248 (254) [258], bind off the remaining 11 sts.



FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1. Do NOT make Buttonholes in this section.

Cast on 50 (55) [61] sts. and work the Holding Position Design. On the LEFT side (right for 2nd section) on every 2nd row, cast on 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x. ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 5x. Knit to Row 78. ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 18th row 5x. Knit to Row 170 (174) [180]. SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back and AT THE SAME TIME, ON FRONT EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 14x (12x) [5x] then decrease 1 st. every 4th row 10x (12x) [19x] AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 246 (260) [276] SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back. Make the 2nd section with reverse shaping, making BUTTONHOLES over needles 5 to 9 counting from the RIGHT edge after the Rows shown on the Chart.




COLLAR: VI

Cast on 75 (81) [87] sts. and work the Holding Position Design. ON EACH SIDE, on every 2nd row, cast on 4 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 3x. After Kow 38, ON EACH SIDE, on every 2nd row, bind off 3 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 3x. After Row 52, bind off the remaining sts.

SLEEVE: III

Cast on 51 (55) [61] sts. and work the Holding Position Design. Knit to Row 14. ON EACH SIDE increase 1 st. every 14th row 13x. Knit to Row 194. SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, on EVERY 4th ROW, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 10x, 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 11x, 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x). [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 11x, 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x]. After Row 250 (254) [258], bind off the remaining 11 sts.









SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x.). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x]. Knit to Row 240 (244) [252]. Bind off the center 12 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 3 sts. 5x, 4 sts. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 6x). [4 sts. 7x, 5 sts. 1x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 6x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit I row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 240 (244) [252] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

KNITTING A MOCK RIB

A MOCK RIB is simulated Ribbing. If you do not own a Ribbing Attachment for your knitting machine, you can use a Mock Rib in place of K1, P1 Ribbing for the bands on garments that call for Ribbing.

The most common Mock Rib is made by having 2 needles in work then I out of work across the needle bed for the number of stitches you need for the cast on. Remember that the empty needles DO count in the stitch gauge and instructions and it is very important that you begin and end with 2 working needles. ALL BANDS must be double the number of rows you would use for bands if you were using a Ribber.... For instance... if a Pattern called for 24 rows Kl, Pl Ribbing, you must knit 48 rows using 1 or 2 tensions lower than the tension given for the body of the garment. Now hang the hem by picking up each cast on stitch and hang it onto its matching needle. There will be 2 stitches on each working needle. KNITKING machine owners should place the stitches behind the latches of the needles while owners of Japanese machines should place the stitches in the hooks of the needles. Before knitting the hem, turn the Tension to the garment Tension, bring the empty needles into working position and knit 1 row.

PREVENTING HOLES ALONG THE HEMLINE

If you were to continue knitting your garment section, you would find small holes along the hem row which will spoil the looks of your finished garment... so before you continue, get rid of those holes. KNITKING machine owners, release the stitches from under the sinkers. The ne that were previously out of work, now hold a The needles cross thread. If you own other than a KNITKING machine, you must place this cross thread behind the needle latches. Hold a Latch Tool in your hand with the HOOK pointing DOWN, catch the cross thread in the hook, pull it off the needle, give it a twist then hang it back onto the empty needle. Do this across the needle bed. Now you may continue with your knitting. When you have finished a section of a garment with Mock Rib hem, take a long ruler or flat stick and put it through the hem, give a good hard pull, downward, so that the stitches go together and form the ribbed look. If you make your Mock Rib hems in this manner, you will find they will not curl up at the hemline.

INCREASING AND DECREASING IN MOCK RIB

Sometime you may want to knit a whole sweater or a dress in a Mock Rib Pattern. There are many needle set-ups for different Ribs - such as... 2 + 1, 3 + 1, 4 + 1, etc., etc... The number 1, always represents the out of work needle while the other numbers represent the needles in working position. If you are INCREASING when working a Mock Rib and the next increase would be an out of work needle, bring this needle into working position, cast on and continue knitting to the next increase row then with the eye end of a transfer tool. transfer the end stitch onto the

next empty needle, leave it in work and put the emptied needle back to the out of work position. For DECREASING, transfer the end stitch IN to the next stitch (2 sts. on 1 needle), push the empty needle to the out of work position. When you need to transfer a single stitch where there is an empty needle, bring the empty needle into working position, transfer the single stitch to it and push the emptied needle back to the out of work position. To sum it all up.... You must always increase or decrease to the next needle regardless of whether it is in working position or an out of work needle.

Here are some lovely trims especially designed for our new Venetia yarn.... Of course you can make them in our other yarns as well, but you may have to adjust the tension. Try all of them.... they are gorgeous....

THE HEAVY HE

PICOT PUFF - Tension 2 or 3 (purl side) Cast on over the 6 needles in work, knit 2 rows. *Counting from the left, put needles 2 and 3 into holding position, knit 4 rows. Bring the needles back into working position. Counting from the left, put needles 1, 4, 5 into holding position, knit 6 rows but always wrap the yarn around the end needle in holding position. Bring the needles back into working position, knit 2 rows. REPEAT from * for as long as you need. Bind off loosely. VARIATION... Do not knit the 2 rows between, just change the needles....

HINVININIVINI LAURIE'S LOOPS- Tension 2 or 3 (purl side) Cast on over the 6 needles in work. Knit 2 rows. *Counting from the left, put needles 1, 2, 3, 4 into holding position, knit 10 rows (do not wrap). Bring I needle at a time back into working position and knit 2 rows (do not wrap)each time. REPEAT from * for as long as you need. Bind off loosely.



LOTUS - Tension 3 or 4 (purl or knit side) Cast on over the 6 needles in work. Knit 2 rows. *Put the 3rd needle from the right into holding position, knit 3 rows. Put the end needle on the left into holding position, knit 7 rows (do not wrap). Put the end needle on left back into working position, knit 1 row. All needles in work, knit I row. REPEAT from * for as long as you need. Bind off loosely.

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








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


