
























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editorial

Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1 means decrease (or increase) 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

< Increase

Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.

Pattern Stitch

Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.

General Instructions

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS ISSUE

FULL FASHION DECREASING AND INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for decreasing or increasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd

stitch, then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd

stitch from the row below and hang

it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the trip control lever so that only 1 row registers.

TO MAKE FRINGE

Cut yarn DOUBLE the length of fringe desired (wind around a cardboard or book). Using 2 or more strands of yarn (depending on weight of yarn) fold in half and with a crochet hook, draw folded loop through knitting from the wrong side. Pull strands through loop and tighten.

To make an additional row of knots on fringe, take half the strands from 1 group and half from the next group, then knot together approximately 1" to 2" below and continue across.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a Cardigan or Jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 Tension Numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows WITHOUT actually counting, by using our KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast-on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7. repeat the above once more ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn, then remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the figuring for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn. Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy..? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.











Cast on 120 (132) [144] sts. with color 1 and work 38 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 18th row 6x. Knit to Row 148. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, i st. 3x]. Knit to Row 240 (244) [248]. Bind off the center 18 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 3 sts. 8x. (3 sts. 5x, 4 sts. 3x). [3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 6x]. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 240 (244) [248] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 56 (62) [68] sts. with color 1 and work 38 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 18th row 6x. Knit to Row 148. SHAPE ARMHOLE AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR ARMHOLE, make the bind-offs the same as the back and ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 17x, every 6th row 6x and after Row 240 (244) [248], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.



FRONT and NECK BANDS: VIII Make 2 and omit Buttonholes in 2nd section.

Cast on 185 (188) [191] sts. with color 2 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. After Row 7, make BUTTONHOLES over the needles as shown on the Chart. After Row 14, bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



SLEEVE: III

Cast on 60 (66) [72] sts. with color 2 and work 28 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch with REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart and ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 11x, every 8th row 7x. Knit to Row 192. SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 20x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x. (3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 22x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x). [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 24x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x]. After Row 250 (254) [258], bind off the remaining 10 (12) [14] sts.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 4 sts. 5x. After Row 226 (230) [234], bring all the needles into working position and bind off.







FOR SHOULDER, bind off 2 sts. 6x, 3 sts. 5x. (2 sts. 5x, 3 sts. 6x). [2 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 7x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 5x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 326 (332) [338] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



Work the front the same as the back to Row 198, then knit to Row 210 (216) [222].

SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back then knit to Row 300 (312) [324].

Bind off the center 8 (10) [12] sts. put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

*ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 6x.



PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

CABLE DESIGNS

In this issue of KNITKING MAGAZINE, there are Patterns which have a Cable Design and on each side of the twisted stitches there is a knit stitch (on the purl side). For example, DK 208 and DK 210 have this type of Cable Design. The easiest way to do this is... After knitting 20 or 30 rows, drop the stitch on each side of the twisted stitches and unravel them, then with a Latch Tool, latch the stitches up into knit stitches and hang them onto the needles... knit 20 or 30 rows and repeat the procedure, continuing with the twisted Cable as shown on the Line Drawing.

KNIT NECK AND ARMHOLE BANDS ONTO GARMENT SECTION

Sometimes it is easier for you to knit the bands for a neck or armhole right onto the garment sections. This is especially true if the bands are narrow and in Ribbing. DK 210 and DK 211 in this issue are good examples.

After blocking your sections, you can sew I shoulder together, then evenly pick up the neck stitches beginning with the open shoulder. Of course, if the back neckband is one section and the front neckband is two sections, you can sew up both shoulders, work the back neckband first, then each of the front sections. When working the armbands, hang a stitch from the shoulder first (as your center stitch) then pick up the stitches evenly on each side. If you are a bit round shouldered, you can space it so that you have an extra 1/2" on the back side of armhole and subtract this amount from the stitches for the front side.

Here is an excerpt from our PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS BOOK which is no longer available. Although it is for a cast-on band, substitute 'pick up' for cast-on, follow the instructions and when you sew up your Ribbed band, it will be perfect.

When using the Ribber, the first and last stitches MUST always be on the main machine. When joining the sections that are ribbed, the seam at the ribbed part is very noticeable. To prevent this and to end up with a continuous ribbing of K1, P1 when weaving seams together, you may use this method... On sleeves, round collars, armbands, etc., cast on an even number of stitches and put the first 2 stitches on the main machine. When knitting the bodice sections of a pullover, one of the sections only should have 2 stitches at each end on the main machine. On front bands that are knitted in 3 sections (which will be joined together), put 2 stitches at each end of the neckband section only, on the main machine. For cardigans and jackets, have two stitches at each end of the back section only on the main machine unless the cast on stitches for the front sections are an even number and in this case put 2 stitches on the side edge of each front section on the main machine. When you join the garment sections, always weave the ribbed part together 1 stitch in on each edge and you will see that the seams are an even Kl, Pl Ribbing.

CHRISTMAS GIFT SLIPPERS

Sometime ago we published a one seam Patterned Slipper. Many of our readers wrote to us saying they make them often as gifts. We are reproducing the Pattern for you to knit for Christmas giving. They are easy and quickly made and make nice bed slippers without the bells.

OPEN CAST ON

DO NOT WRAP THE NEEDLES WHEN WORKING PATTERN DESIGN

MATERIAL: 2 balls Flamingo Dralon will make one pair. Wax the yarn when winding into a ball. SIZE: Small, Medium, Large. There are two widths for the slippers. The narrow width is like a ballet slipper, the wider width is for those who like the slipper to come up higher on the foot. TENSION: 7. KNITKING machine owners, use NEEDLE SHIFTER every 4 rows. The Purl side is the right side.

Set up the needles as shown in the Line Drawing - having 18 sts. in working position for the ballet type - 22 sts. in working position for the wider width. Use open cast-on with waste yarn. Knit several rows, ending with Cam Box on the LEFT side. Change to Main Yarn and knit 1 row to the right side. Turn Counter to 0. Knit in Pattern to: Row 316 for small size; Row 364 for medium size; Row 412 for large size.

(for extra large size, add 48 rows). Bring all the needles into working position and knit 1 row. Hang the first row of main yarn onto the needles in front of the latches, then knit these stitches through the ones in back of the latches. Bring 1 of the empty needles in each section (of those out of work) into working position and with Tension 10, knit 1 row, then bind off all stitches using the crochet method, dropping the yarn held on the original empty needles..(this was only to make binding off easier and to keep the bind-off elastic). Remove the waste yarn.

CORD: Make 2. Tension 1 to 3. Cast on 3 sts. Set your machine for knitting a cord. KNITKING machine owners, push back the right Cam Control Button and leave it there. (the empty rows do count). Knit 300 rows for small; 330 rows for medium; 350 rows for large and extra large.

FINISHING: Fold slipper in half and beginning at bind off end, and with right sides together, over cast the two bottom edges together. Run cord through openings at top so that you can tie in front. Put bells on ends (or beads) of ties.
