DK 8152 — Take your holiday in stride and be sure to pack this sunny bright outfit. The pants are beautifully shaped and the short top with its scooped neckline and striped Sleeves a fashion headline. Knit Size 10 with KNITKING Subita Crepe 2 x 3; Size 12 with Beatrice; Size 16 with Crocus Crepe.



The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Skirt: Stockinette Stitch; Jacket: Norwegian Design according to the Line Drawing. Use the adjustable needle selector. In the instructions, each row in the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row, but several movements of the Cam Box are needed to complete 1 row. DECREASES: Skirt: Hang the 4th st. onto the 3rd st.; Begin the Darts by hanging the sts. together as marked in the Diagrams. The following decreases for the Darts lie directly above. Move the sts. together after ALL decreases to fill the empty needles; JACKET: Hang the 1st st. onto the 2nd st. INCREASES: Place the end st. from the row below onto the next empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. SKIRT: Weave the sections together, 1 st. in from each edge. FINISHING: Block all sections. SKIRT: Weave the sections together, 1 st. in from each edge. Turn under 19 rows on lower edge and 14 rows on upper edge and hem to wrong side. Insert an elastic band into the upper hem. JACKET: Join back and front sections at sides and shoulders, easing in the fullness at bustline of the front sections. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Turn under 18 rows on lower edge and 14 rows on sleeve edges and hem to wrong side. Turn under 9 rows on upper edges of the pockets, then hem to wrong side. Sew the pockets in place. Sew 1 edge of the band to inside and 1 edge to outside of the front edges and around neckline, leaving 5 spaces of about ½" on the right front edge for the buttonholes. Begin the first buttonhole space about 6%" from the lower edge, the following spaces are about 2" apart Finish the buttonholes sew on buttons. apart. Finish the buttonholes, sew on buttons.





Bring the needles on the left side into working position, knit 1 row in PATTERN to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 338 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*.

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 338 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 339 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 340, 341, 342, 343, 344; 3 sts. after Row 345; 5 sts. after Row 346; 3 sts. after Row 347; 5 sts. after Row 348; 3 sts. after Row 340; 5 sts. after Row 348; 3 sts. after Row 349; 5 sts. after Rows 350, 352.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 250, 251; 3 sts. after Rows 252, 253, 254, 255; 2 sts. after Rows 256, 257, 258, 259, 260, 261; 1 st. after Rows 262, 263, 264, 265, 266, 267, 268, 269, then knit to Row 338, bind off the center 19 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 166, 178, 190, 202, 214, 226, 238, then knit to Row 250.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 46, 54, 62, 70, 76, 82, 88, 94, 100, 106, 112, 118, 124, 130, 136, 142, 148, then knit to Row 166.

ROWS 0 to 46: Knit even.

Cast on 13 sts. with color 2 and knit 800 rows stockinette st., then bind off all sts.

Cast on 193 sts. and work the Norwegian





ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 129; 11 sts. after Row 130.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 28, 32, 36, 40, 44, 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, then knit to Row 70.

ROWS 0 to 28: Knit even.

Cast on 107 sts. and work the Norwegian Design.





The instructions are the same for all sizes, PATTERN: Stockinette Stitch, TRIM: Knitted cords. BELT: K1, P1, Ribbing. DECREASES: Sides: Hang the 4th st. onto the 3rd st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. Front edges: Hang the 26th st. onto the 25th st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. Begin the waistline Darts by 25th st., then move the end sts. Inward to fill the empty needle. Begin the waistine Darks by hanging the sts. together as marked on the Diagrams, then move the sts. together to fill the empty needles. The following decreases then increase for the Darts lie directly above. INCREASES: Move the 2 end sts. 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below onto the empty needle. To form the hem, hang the cast-on sts. back onto the machine behind the latches, then knit the following row with 1 or 2 tension settings higher.

FINISHING: Block all sections. Join back and front sections at sides and shoulders. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Weave the open sts. of the facing together, then sew the facing to neckline. Turn under 12 sts. on the front edges and on the neckline and hem to wrong side. For the trim, knit cords over 3 sts. with tension 1. (See Practical Knitting Hints Book, page 58). For the front knit 1 cord 1700 rows. For the sleeves knit 2 cords 250 rows. (The empty rows do count). Sew the cords in place. (See picture). Finish the buttonholes, sew on buttons.



Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 482 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



Cast on 190 sts. and work stockinette st.







For SHOULDER bind off 3 sts. after Rows 500, 502, (502), 504, (505), 506, 508; (508), 4 sts. after Rows 510, (511), 512, 514. Knit over the remaining 24 sts. (FACING) to Row 560, then put these sts. onto a stitch holder.

Increase 2 sts. for the DART after Rows in (). ON CAM BOX SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 312, (312), 324, (330), 336, 348, (348), (B.H. 350), 360, (366), 372, then knit to Row 373 and work Short Rows for the BUST DART. ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX put into holding position 4 needles after Rows 373, 375, 377, 379, 381, 383, 385, 387, 389. After Row 391 bring all needles back into working position, make buttonholes after Row 396, then knit to Row 400.

Decrease 2 sts. for the Waistline DART after (DART). Decrease 1 st. ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX after Rows in (). Make buttonholes over the 2nd-6th and 19th-23rd sts. counting from the left side after (B.H.). ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 66, (66), 80, (88), 94, 108, (110), (B.H. 120), 122, (132), 136, 150, (154), 164, (B.H. 166), (174), 178, 192, (194), 206, (B.H. 212), 214, (214), 222, 230, (234), (238, (DART 240), 246, 254, (254), (B.H. 258), (DART 258), 262, 270, (274), (DART 276), 278, 286, 294, (294), (DART 294), (B.H. 304), then knit to Row 312.

ROWS 19 to 66: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 18: Knit even, then cast on 24 sts. ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX. (Use a separate length of yarn).

Cast on 115 sts. and work stockinette st.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 22, 23, 24, 25; 2 sts. after Rows 26, 27. After Row 28, change to color 2 and work the color stripes as marked in the Diagram. Continue to bind off 2 sts. ON CAM BOX SIDE after Rows 28, 29. ON EACH SIDE, hang the 1st st. onto the 2nd st. after Rows 30, 32, 34, 36, 38. After Row 40 continue working with color 1. Continue to decrease 1 st. ON EACH SIDE after Row 40, 42, 44, 46, 48. ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Row 50, 51; 3 sts. after Rows 52, 53, 54, 55; 10 sts. after Row 56.

ROWS 11 to 22: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 10: Knit even, then change to stockinette st.

Cast on 66 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1, Ribbing.




Work 3 more sections the same.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 48, 54, 60, 66, 72, 78, 84, 90, 96, 102, 108, 114, 120, 126, then knit to Row 148 and bind off the remaining 45 sts.

Cast on 73 sts. with color 1 and work stockinette st.



FINISHING: Block all sections. SKIRT: Weave the sections together, 1 st. in from each edge. Turn under 20 rows on lower edge and 11 rows on upper edge and hem to wrong side. Insert an elastic band into the upper hem. PULLOVER: Join front and back section at sides. Close shoulders %". Turn under a small amount on the open edges and hem to wrong side. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Sew the neckbands to neckline. Work 4 loops and sew 4 buttons to each shoulder.





Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 150 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*.

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 150 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING), 151 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING), 152, 153, 154, 155, 156; 5 sts. after Row 158.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 100, 101; 2 sts. after Rows 102, 103, 104, 105; 1 st. after Rows 106, 107, 108, 109. After Row 118 change to color 1. Knit to Row 150, then bind off the center 12 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first. (For the Front Section knit to ROW 138).

ROWS 21 to 100: After Row 70 work the color stripes as marked in the Diagram, Knit to Row 100.

ROWS 0 to 20: Knit even, then change to stockinette st.

Cast on 96 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 138 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*.

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 139, 141 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 2 sts. after Rows 143, 145, 147; 1 st. after Row 149; 4 sts. after Row 150 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 1 st. after Row 151; 4 sts. after Rows 152, 154, 156; 5 sts. after Row 158.

Work the front section the same as the back section to ROW 138, then bind off the center 8 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 312 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING), 313 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING), 314, 315, 316, 317, 318, 319, 320; 2 sts. after Row 321; 3 sts. after Row 322; 2 sts. after Row 323; 3 sts. after Row 324; 2 sts. after Row 325; 3 sts. after Row 326; 2 sts. after Row 327; 4 sts. after Rows 328, 330.


ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 208, 209, 210, 211; 2 sts. after Rows 212, 213, 214, 215, 216, 217; 1 st. after Rows 218, 219, 220, 221, 222, 223, 224, 225, 226, 227, 228, 229, then knit to Row 312, bind off the center 12 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 86, 110, 134, 158, 182, then knit to Row 208. (For the Front Section knit to ROW 184).


ROWS 35 to 86: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 34: Knit even, then change to stockinette st. and work the Pattern Stitch.

Cast on 142 sts. and work K1, P1, Ribbing.



Cast on 149 sts. and work 68 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all sts.




ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 70, 71, 72, 73; 2 sts. after Rows 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, 79. ON EACH SIDE, hang the 1st st. onto the 2nd st. after Rows 80, 82, 84, 86, 88, 90, 92, 94, 96, 98, 100, 102, 104, 106, 108, 10, 112, 114, 116, 118, 120, 122, 124, 126, 128, 130. ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 132, 133, 134, 135; 3 sts. after Rows 136, 137, 138, 139; 10 sts. after Row 140.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 18, 26, 34, 40, 46, 52, 58, 64, then knit to Row 70.

ROWS 0 to 18: Knit even, then change to stockinette st. and work the Pattern Stitch.

Cast on 90 sts. and work K1, P1, Ribbing.



Bring the needles on the left side into working position, knit 1 row in PATTERN to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 296 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*:

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 297, 299 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 2 sts. after Rows 301, 303; 1 st. after Rows 305, 307, 309, 311, 315, 319, 323, 327; 3 sts. after Row 330 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 1 st. after Row 331; 3 sts. after Rows 332, 334, 336, 338, 340, 342, 344; 4 sts. after Rows 346, 348.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 226, 227, 228, 229; 2 sts. after Rows 230, 231, 232, 233, 234, 235; 1 st. after Rows 236, 237, 238, 239, 240, 241, 242, 243, 244, 245, 246, 247, then knit to Row 296, bind off the center 14 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

Work the front section the same as the back section to ROW 184, then work Short Rows for the DARTS. ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX put into holding position 4 needles after Rows 184, 185, 186, 187, 188, 189, 190, 191, 192, 193, 194, 195, 196, 197, 198, 199, 200, 201. ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX bring back into working position all needles after Rows 202, 203, then knit to Row 226.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 192 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 5 sts. after Row 226 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 8 sts. after Row 227 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 5 sts. after Row 228; 4 sts. after Row 229; 5 sts. after Row 230; 3 sts. after Row 231; 6 sts. after Row 232; 3 sts. after Row 233; 6 sts. after Row 234.

*ROWS 193 to 226: Knit even.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 158, 159; 2 sts. after Rows 160, 161, 162, 163, 164, 165; 1 st. after Rows 166, 167, 168, 169, 170, 171, then knit to Row 192, put 45 needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first. (For the Front Section knit to ROW 192, but do not divide the sts.).

ROWS 25 to 158: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 24: Knit even, then change to stockinette st.

Cast on 114 sts. and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 208 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*.

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 209, 211; 2 sts. after Rows 213, 215; 1 st. after Rows 217, 219, 221, 223. For SHOULDER bind off 5 sts. after Rows 226, 228, 230; 6 sts. after Rows 232, 234.

ROWS 193 to 208: Knit even, then bind 234 the left side into holding position and 226 complete the right half first.

Work the front section the same as the back section to ROW 192.

The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Stockinette Stitch and color stripes as marked in the Diagram of the back section. BANDS: K1, P1, Ribbing. DECREASES: ON EACH SIDE, hang the 3rd st. onto the 2nd st. Begin the DARTS by hanging the sts. together as marked in the Diagram. Always move the sts. together to fill the empty needles.


FINISHING: Block all sections. Join front and back section at sides and shoulders. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Turn under 2" at lower edge and hem to wrong side. Gather the lower edge of the sleeves to about 8", then sew the sleeve bands in place. Gather the upper edge of the sleeves to fit in armhole. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Sew the neckband to neckline. Work 1 row of slip st. crochet around the back opening, then sew in a zipper.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 186 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from*.

*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 187, 189, 191; 1 st. after Rows 193, 195, 197, 199. For SHOULDER bind off 4 sts. after Rows 200, 202, 204, 206; 5 sts. after Row 208.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 150, 151; 2 sts. after Rows 152, 153, 154, 155, 156, 157; 1 st. after Rows 158, 159, 160, 161, 162, 163, then knit to Row 186, bind off the center 10 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

Work the front section the same as the back section to ROW 150.







FLOWER CORSAGE

MATERIAL: 1 50 gr. ball color of your choice; 1 50 gr. ball Green; small amount of Yellow KNITKING Melodie (will make 4 or 5 flowers) Soft Green Florists wire; Pin back — about 1". TENSION 10: USE EVERY OTHER NEEDLE.



EVERY OTHER NEEDLE. Put the 1st and every 6th needle into holding position and knit 12 rows. Be sure to wrap the yarn around the end needle in holding position before knitting each row. Bring all the needles back into working position. (KNITKING MA-CHINE owners, push back the Left Retractor Button before knitting the 12th row, then release button). Right the Retractor Button before knitting the 12th row, then release button). Bring the yarn UNDER the end needle, then over and knit this 1 st. by hand, then put it into holding position and knit 1 row over the rest of the needles. If you have a machine other than KNITKING, you may have to knit this one row by hand because of the many strands of yarn over each 6th needle. Break yarn, leaving a long end. Tie the cast-on yarn and the strand of yarn tightly against the last row. Thread a tapestry needle with end of yarn, release all sts. from under the sinkers and take each st. off onto end of

UNIT 2 - 5 Petals. Cast on 31 sts. and work the same as Unit 1, but knit only

UNIT 3 - 3 Petals. Cast on 19 sts. and work the same as Unit 1 and 2, but knit

LEAVES: Cast on 9 sts. over every needle. Tension 10. Knit 4 rows. *Bring the center needle into holding position, knit 1 row, return the needle to working position, knit 1 row. Continue from but at the same time, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. till one remains. Bind off. Pull up the cast on tightly. Make 2 more leaves, but cast on 11 sts. instead of 9.


STEM: Make a cord over 3 needles with Tension 3 (every needle). (KNITKING machine owners, push back the Right Cam Control Button to make cord) and knit 108 rows (empty rows do count).

FINISHING: Pull Unit 3 through center of Unit 2, then both through Unit 1. Thread one of the strands into a sharp needle and take a few stitches through center of petals to hold them in place. With Yellow, make 5 french knots in center of flower. Arrange leaves under flower so they will peak out from petals flower so they will peak out from petals (see picture) and sew in place. Run wire through center of cord, arrange pleasingly, then sew securely on back of flower. Sew on pin back.







Our fantastic new accessory is really setting the machine knitting world on its ear... Entire shipments are sold out before we receive them... The popularity of the Pattern Reader in all parts of the world is so great that our factory in West Germany is experiencing difficulty keeping up with orders... If you had to wait a couple of weeks for your WHIZ KING, please accept our apologies. All orders from owners of KNITKING machines are now being filled within a week of their arrival and we expect very shortly to ship within two days (see section 6 below if you own another brand of knitter)... So, please get you order in as soon as possible. Your WHIZ KING will immediately become your most used accessory.

Hundreds of letters are coming in with inquiries about Charts and Charting services, etc... We cannot answer them all individually without a great deal of delay, so we will try to cover the most frequent questions herewith.

- Your WHIZ KING will arrive complete with Instruction Book and an illustrated Booklet with 50 pictures from past and future editions of KNITKING MAGAZINE plus four sets of Charts for practice work.
- 2. The practice Charts are for simple to make garments and they include:
 - A. Girl's Cardigan in sizes for 5 to 10 years.
 - B. Man's Sleeveless Pullover Sizes
 - C. Boy's Pullover Sizes for ages from 6 to 10.
 - D. Women's or Teen's Pullover Sizes from 6 to 16.

We think that the practice Charts include something for every WHIZ KING owner and that after one garment is completed using them, the making of garments from Pattern Reader Charts will be child's play....

- 3. After completing your practice garment, you should order any of the sets of Charts from the 50 illustrated in the Booklet. They each are in a range of sizes and will vary in price according to the number of pieces in a set. Prices are between \$1.00 and \$3.00... If you buy the KNITKING YARNS that the original garments were made with, sets of Charts will be furnished free of charge.
- 4. We are accumulating at KNITKING headquarters an assortment of equipment necessary to draw custom Charts speedily and accurately. Speed is necessary in order to provide Charts at low prices... Again, Charts will be free where KNITKING YARNS are used... If you wish to use other brands of yarn, you will most likely need to send your knitted swatch to us, but watch this magazine for

full information as we are not yet set up for custom Charting.

- 5. If you like to do your own charting, the special graph paper needed is available from us at the introductory price of 8 sheets for \$2.00 plus 20¢ mailing costs... Because graph paper is drawn in stitches and rows, the drawing of your own charts becomes relatively simple.
- 6. WHIZ KING PATTERN READER accessories are made primarily for KNITKING machine, Model AM 3... but, its basic operating principal can be adapted to any brand of machine... We will make adaptors only for the most popular brands... When you order your WHIZ KING, you must tell us the brand and Model Number you are ordering it for... If we cannot provide adaptors for your machine, we will refund your money... In any case, there will be a small delay in supplying WHIZ KING'S for brands of machines other than KNITKING because of the adaptor problems, so please be patient with us and you will find your PATTERN READER well worth waiting for.

SHORT ROW KNITTING

We did not have space in our last issue of KNIT-KING MAGAZINE to complete the article on knitting Short Rows... so here are the two other methods..

METHOD NO. 2: This is a quickie method - not as good as the first one, but it is OK for making baby booties using a fine 2-ply yarn... for shaping Headbands... and a variety of household items such as round Potholders or placemats etc., etc. With a light weight yarn, using tension 3 or 4, cast on 31 sts. Knit 20 rows. ON SAME SIDE AS CAM BOX, put 1 needle into holding position before each of the next 24 rows. Wrap the yarn around the inside needle this ONE TIME ONLY, then ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position, 1 needle before each of the next 24 rows (do not wrap the yarn). Knit 20 rows, then bind off. Pull sample into shape and look at the heel (or toe) you have just made... It looks a bit different than the other and has a tiny hole where the short rows are made.

METHOD NO. 3: SELF WRAP SHORT ROWS

This type of Short Row is almost as good as Method No. 1, but not quite. It is fine for knitting with heavy weight yarns especially and mohairs... good for socks and slippers. Cast on 40 sts. Knit 20 rows. ON SAME SIDE AS CAM BOX, put 1 needle into holding position before each of the next 34 rows. Wrap the yarn around the inside needle in holding position THIS ONE TIME ONLY. Now *ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring 2 needles back into working position, knit across, then put the INSIDE NEEDLE BACK INTO HOLDING POSITION. REPEAT from * until all the needles are back in working position.

SELF WRAP SHORT ROWS can also be made when you are putting the needles into holding position, but this should only be used where you will immediately bind off the sts... such as in shoulder

or neck shaping. For example: Cast on 40 sts., knit 20 rows using tension 5 or 6. Now*ON OPPO-SITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, Put 7 needles into holding position, knit across, then bring the inside needle that is in holding position, back into working position (6 are left in hold). REPEAT from * 3 times more. Now ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring ALL the needles back into working position before knitting the next 2 rows and be sure to turn your tension UP at least 3 numbers so that you knit the LAST ROW with a loose tension and then bind off the crochet method.

TRIMS

Trims are fun to make and you can always add to your own collection. Here are three lovely ones that are quick and easy to make. Remember to begin and end using contrast waste yarn, then you can always add to, or take off rows if you need to. Some trims can be made wider by adding extra stitches... experiment a bit and you will come up with some new trims of your own.

SWIRL: Allegro Dralon. Tension 5 to 7.


Bring 8 needles into working position. Counting from the right, put the 5th needle back into the out of work position and leave it there. Cast on over the remaining 7 needles. Knit 2 rows.

*Counting from the right, put needles 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 into holding position, knit 4 rows over 1

needle in work. Counting from the right, bring back into working position 1 needle, knit 4 rows 3 x (4 needles in work). Bring all the needles into working position and knit 6 rows. REPEAT from * for as long as you need. Pull into shape and press lightly.

ALI-LOOP: Allegro Dralon. Tension 6 to 8. Bring 11 needles into working position. Counting from the right, put back into the out of work position, needles 4, 7, 9 and leave them there. Cast on over the remaining 8 needles. Knit 2 rows. *Counting from the right, put needles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 into holding position, knit 6 rows. Bring back into working position needles 3, 4, 5, 7, 8. Knit 3 rows. Return needle 6 to working position and knit 3 rows. REPEAT from * for as long as you need. Press lightly.

REVERSIBLE (Piecrust on Purl side, Loops on Knit side). Subita 2 x 3: Tension 3 or 4... Allegro Dralon: Tension 5 to 7. Cast on 9 sts. Knit 2 rows. *ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX, put 6 needles into holding position, knit 10 rows. Bring all the needles back into working position, knit 3 rows. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put 6 needles into holding position, knit 10 rows. Bring all the needles into working position, knit 3 rows. REPEAT from * for as long as you need. Pull down strongly so that the piecrust forms on the purl side. No need to press.

NOTES TO KNIT BY . . .

STITCH AND ROW GAUGE

KNIT A SAMPLE SWATCH . . . before you begin to knit any garment . . . for this is the MOST IMPORTANT STEP toward the correct size and the proper fit of any garment you wish to make. You MUST use the SAME YARN for your sample swatch that you will use to knit your garment and your sample swatch must be knitted large enough and using several different tension numbers on your machine. When you have done this, then you can determine the number of stitches and the number of rows in a two-inch measure. KNITKING MAGAZINE PATTERNS give you 3 tensions to try and one of them should give you the correct stitch and row gauge if you are using the yarn we recommend or a similar weight yarn. Here is the way to make your sample swatch.

Cast on over a sufficient number of needles to produce a swatch at least 4 inches wide. (If the pattern calls for 16 stitches to 2", then $16 \times 2 = 32$ stitches to cast on). Now knit 4 inches of rows at the first suggested tension number. (If the pattern calls for 22 rows to 2", $22 \times 2 = 44$ rows to knit). Knit 2 rows using a contrast color, change to the next higher tension and with garment yarn knit another 4", knit 2 rows with contrast color, change to the 3rd higher tension and knit another 4" and then bind off.

Roll the swatch into a cylinder over its length and pull on both ends, unroll it and stretch it diagonally by pulling on the four corners. Allow the swatch to rest and settle (preferably overnight) and then using a stitch gauge or a ruler, count the number of stitches over a 2" width, then the number of rows over a 2" length in EACH of the 3 tensions. Select the tension number that produces the stitches and rows called for in the pattern. If none of them are correct, you are most likely using the wrong weight of yarn.

READING OF CHARTS

You will notice the instructions start at the bottom of the Chart and work UP. Follow the charts exactly as written and providing your sample stitch and row gauge is correct, your garment will come out the right size. Please remember that the section of garment as it is knitted on the machine, faces the same way as the Charts are in this magazine. Where two front pieces are needed, (or any other part of a garment that needs two sections) only one section is normally shown and the second section is usually made with reverse shaping. Set in sleeves are usually identical, but raglan sleeves have to be knitted with reverse shaping for the second sleeve.

READING OF SYMBOLS

To simplify Pattern Knitting, we use Symbols in the Line Drawings and the Chart Diagrams. In the Line Drawings the symbols are shown and are to be read as you look at them while knitting a garment. For instance, if a Purl stitch faces you, the Purl stitch Symbol is shown; if a knit stitch faces you (as when using the Ribber) then this Symbol is shown. The Symbol at the top of the Line Drawing is the center of the garment section and you use this as a guide for setting up the needles.

The following Symbols are used for Eyelet Designs in the Line Drawings and also for Full Fashion shaping on the Charts. The Line Drawings have row numbers on the right side. Missing Row numbers are always knitted straight or plain.

In Holding Position Designs selected needles are pushed into holding position for the stated number of rows. The numbers of rows appear at the right of the Line Drawings; Example: 1—4 means knit Rows 1 to 4; 5 to 7 means knit Rows 5 to 7, etc. This same Symbol is also shown on the Charts and is used for putting needles into holding position for Short Rows. The

Symbol on the Charts is used to put needles back into working position when knitting Short Rows.

A number in a box stands for the number of rows to be knitted between shapings. Make shaping first, then knit the necessary number of rows. If for instance it reads: 1 st. $8 \times$

6 1 st. 10 x

As you will be reading the instructions from the bottom up, here is the way you will follow them: . . . Decrease or increase (depending on the direction of the garment outline) 1 st. at the row where the shaping begins, then knit 8 rows, make the next decrease, then knit 8 rows, until you have decreased (or increased) 1 st. 10 x and you have knitted 8 rows after each decrease (or increase) (1 st. 10 x +8 rows 10 x). Now begin the first decrease (or increase) for the shaping (which has to be made 8 x) in every 6th row. Decrease (or increase) 1 st. first, then knit 6 rows until you have decreased 1 st. 6 x and after each decrease (or increase) have knitted 6 rows (1 st. 8 x + 6 rows 8 x).

Where shapings are given without a boxed number as on most armholes, necklines, etc., make the shapings on every second row (on each side of course).

(See below for more Pattern Stitch Symbols.)

PATTERN STITCH SYMBOLS

= knit stitch

= purl stitch

= empty needle (leave in working position)

= needle not used (in the out of work position)

= needle in the holding position

Needles back into working position.

= 2 stitches on 1 needle either transferred from the right side or the left side, then put the needle into holding position

needle holding 2 stitches.
 Stitch has been transferred from the LEFT

= needle holding 2 stitches. Stitch has been transferred from the RIGHT

= 3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 needles has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

= Center of Garment Section.

8 = Number of rows to be knitted between shapings.

The diagrams (Line Drawings) for pattern work are followed just as they are shown and are to be read as you look at them while knitting the garment.
