




















KNITTING A TENSION SWATCH AND PATTERN DRAWING

Methods of tension swatch knitting and pattern drawing depend on the gate pegs you use.





- Refer to the "Tension Swatch 1" on the knitting machine manual to know how to knit a tension swatch.
- •When you use knit leader with 7mm pitch knitting machine, use the method 8, but if the width of 20 stitches is less than 8cm or the length of 30 rows is less than 6cm, double-the width of 20 stitches and length of 30 rows to get the measurement of 40 stitches and 60 rows and use method A.

NOTE

- Make sure that the carnage kicks the feeding lever every row.
- For detail instruction except explanation on this sheet, refer to the pages of knit leader manual from 8.
