The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Norwegian Design that follows the Line Drawing. In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box are needed to complete 1 row. DECREASES: Hang the 2nd st. onto the 3rd st. and move the end st. in to fill the empty needle. INCREASES: Move the end st. 1 needle outward, then pick up the 2nd st. from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle. NECKBAND: Stockinette stitch.

FINISHING: Block all sections. Join side and shoulder seams. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge of dress. Sew short ends of neckband together and sew 1 edge to inside and 1 to outside of neckline. Turn under and sew hem.







Move the Cam Box to the left, bring all the needles into working position, turn the Row Counter back to 436 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from \*.

\*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 5 sts. after Row 436 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 4 sts. after Row 437 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 5 sts. after Row 438; 4 sts. after Row 439; 5 sts. after Row 440; 3 sts. after Row 441; 5 sts. after Row 442; 3 sts. after Row 443; 5 sts. after Rows 444, 446, 448.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 352, 353; 3 sts. after Rows 354, 355, 356, 357; 2 sts. after Rows 358, 359, 360, 361, 362, 363; 1 st. after Rows 364, 365, 366, 367, 368, 369, 370, 371, 372, 373, then knit to Row 436. Bind off the center 23 sts. put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 278, 286, 294, 302, 310, 318, 326, 334. Knit to Row 352 (336 for front section).

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 176, 182, 188, 194, 200, 206, 212, 218, 224, 230, 234, 238, 242, 246, 250. Knit to Row 278.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 62, 80, 98 (change to Stockinette stitch after Row 100) 116, 134, 152, 170. Knit to Row 176.

ROWS 0 to 36: Knit even then change to the Norwegian Design.

Cast on 191 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.



Cast on 111 sts. and work 22 rows Stockinette stitch, then bind off all sts.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 432, bring the needles into working position and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from\*.


ON CAM BOX SIDE, shape shoulder by binding off 5 sts. after Rows 452, 454, 456, 458, 460, 462, 464.

\*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 431, 433 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 2 sts. after Rows 435, 437, 439; 1 st. after Rows 441, 443, 445, 447. Knit to Row 452.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 368, 369; 3 sts. after Rows 370, 371, 372, 373; 2 sts. after Rows 374, 375, 376, 377, 378, 379; 1 st. after Rows 380, 381, 382, 383, 384, 385, 386, 387, 388, 389. Knit to Row 430, bind off the center 19 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.


ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 4 needles after Rows 336, 337, 338, 339, 340, 341, 342, 343, 344, 345, 346, 347, 348, 349, 350, 351. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring all the needles back into working position after Rows 352, 353. Knit even to Row 368.

Work the front section the same as the back section to Row 336, then work Short Rows.



ROWS 0 to 22: Knit even, then change to the Norwegian Design.

Cast on 67 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.



JACKET Sleeves and Bands: Stockinette stitch. SKIRT: Stockinette stitch. DECREASES in Pattern: Hang the 2nd st. onto the 3rd st. and move the end st. in to fill the empty needle. INCREASES: Move the end st. 1 needle outward then pick up the 2nd st. from the row below and place it onto the empty needle. INCREASES in Stockinette stitch: Move the 2 end sts. 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd st. from the row below and place it onto the empty needle. DECREASES: Hang the 3rd st. onto the 2nd st. then move the end sts. in to fill the empty needle.


FINISHING: Block all sections. JACKET: Join sides and shoulders easing in the fullness at bustline of front section. Sew sleeves together and set in. Make a 1½" hem at lower edge. Fold bands in half lengthwise and sew 1 edge to inside and 1 to outside of front edges. Sew neckband to Jacket in same way. Sew in Zipper. SKIRT: Weave back and front sections together 1 st. in from each edge. Fold waistband in half and hem to the inside then insert elastic through hem. Turn under and hem 18 rows on lower edge.





Cast on 85 sts. with color 1 and work 14 rows Stockinette stitch, 24 rows Pattern, 6 rows Stockinette stitch, 24 rows Pattern, 6 rows Stockinette stitch with color 1 and AT THE SAME TIME ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 24, 30, 36, 42, (continue in Pattern after Row 44) 48, 54, 60, 66, 72, 78, 84, 90. Knit to Row 110.



ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 198, 199; 3 sts. after Rows 200, 201, 202, 203, 204, 205; 2 sts. after Rows 206, 207, 208, 209, 210, 211. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. 211. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 19x. ON EACH SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 250, 251, 252, 253; 3 sts. after Rows 254, 255, 256, 257; 4 sts. after Rows 258, 259; 11 sts. after Row 260.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 36, 44, 52, 60, 68, 76, 84, 92, 100, 108, 116, 124, 132, 140, 148, 156, 162, 168, 174, 180, 186, 192, then knit to Row 198.

ROWS 0 to 36: Knit even.

Cast on 71 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.

FINISHING: Block all sections. Join side and shoulder seams. Sew sleeve seams and set in. Fold under 32 rows on lower edge and hem. Fold under 36 rows on sleeves and hem. Fold over 11 sts. on the front edges and hem to the wrong side. Fold collar in half lengthwise and sew the short ends then sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 edge to the outside of neckline.

# Knitking New/

#### OUR READERS WRITE

Some subscribers write to tell us they have problems when putting their garments together - they end up with one edge shorter than the other... or a neckband or armhole band looks lopsided... Well, there is a solution easy as can be... but you must REMEMBER to follow a simple procedure for marking your garments as you knit, then we can promise your troubles will disappear.... SO....

#### MARK.... MARK... MARK....

Tie a small piece of contrast waste yarn on each end needle after knitting approximately 100 rows all along a section of garment. Remember this means you should mark the front and back sections of a pullover, dress, jacket, sleeve, every section of a skirt or pants. If you are knitting extra rows in place of knitting a bust dart, then you should mark where the extra rows begin and again where they end, so that you know these are the rows to be eased into the back section at the bust level. ALWAYS MARK the center of each neck section, the center of a collar, the center of a neckband or armband. Don't make a hard knot, just tie it once so that it will be easy to pull out later.

When you have all the sections of your garment knitted and blocked, it is very easy to pin the sections together matching the markers of yarn along the side edges. The center mark on the neckband will match the center front or back at neckline - or it could go on the shoulder seam if the neckband is made in one section and you want the seam of the band at the shoulder. Sew or weave your seams together making sure the markers meet exactly and if they do not, then you only need to pull out a few rows to go back and make those rows match up nicely. Match the armband seam at the underarm and the center marking on band at the shoulder seam or if you are round shouldered, put the center marking of the band slightly toward the back of shoulder seam to allow a little extra room over the shoulder (the band won't pull up then). Pin the center of a collar to the center back neck then pin the front edges in place and distribute the rest of the collar evenly around the neckline. ALWAYS pin first, then sew in place If you will remember to mark as you knit, you will always have garments that are easy to put together and are professional in appearance.

#### PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

#### USING OUT OF WORK POSITION FOR HOLDING STITCHES

If you are knitting a Pattern Stitch and want to work on one side at a time, when you reach the neck and shoulder shaping, you cannot put the needles of the left side into the normal holding position because when using the Retractor Buttons and Push Button controls of the KNITKING machine or the Push Buttons and Cam Levers of a Japanese machine for your design, the needles in the normal holding position will operate when you do not wish them to. Some knitters take the left side stitches off onto contrast waste yarn and after completing the right half, hang the left side stitches back onto the machine. This is terribly time consuming and it is so easy to make a mistake... but there IS another method that works beautifully for all machines and this is the way it goes....

When your Pattern says to bind off the center neck stitches, the first thing to do is write down the Pattern Row Number. Now take a Ravel Cord and knit each of the center neck stitches by hand, pulling each stitch all the way back against the back rail of your machine (out of work position) with the stitch held in the HOOK of the needle. Continue using the Ravel Cord to knit across all of the remaining stitches on the left half of the garment.

Now you can go ahead and work the right half of the neck and the right shoulder shaping. If you own a Japanese machine, you should place a strip of Scotch Tape across the knitting being held on the Ravel Cord.... Place the strip lightly across the knitting on the left side only right underneath the sinker pegs because if you do not do this, the fabric brushes on the Slide will rub against the knitting as you work on the right side and make unsightly fuzz. Do not press hard on the tape, it will hold if you gently put it on and then when you need to remove it, it will come away easily without spoiling your knitting.

After you have completed the right half, begin on the left side and pull the Ravel Cord toward you gently, unravelling the cord so that the last row of knitting returns to the needles. Be careful to stop at the left edge of the center neck stitches. KNITKING machine owners, put the stitches behind the latches and under the sinkers, the needles in working position, knit I row in Pattern (check your Pattern Row Number) to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to the proper row and continue in pattern as you shape the left half. Japanese machine owners, leave the stitches in the HOOKS of the needles, remove the Scotch Tape, knit I row in Pattern (check Pattern Row Number) to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to the correct number and complete the left half.

When shaping the neck and shoulders you can bind off the neck and shoulder stitches or you can use the Short Row Method to be bound off when the shaping is completed... A beginner in machine knitting will find it easier to bind off the stitches as she shapes a garment, but an experienced knitter will usually prefer to use the Short Row method for neck and shoulder shapings. In either case, you will find the above method for holding stitches of the left half while you knit the right half....absolutely great.!!

#### MARKING BUTTON BANDS

When knitting the front sections of a sweater, jacket or dress that has buttonholes - or separate buttonhole bands, you are given the rows on which to make the buttonholes... so... when knitting the button side, or button bands, use the same row numbers used for making buttonholes and tie in a piece of contrast yarn at each buttonhole row, then when you finish the buttonholes, the mark of contrast yarn on the button band shows you exactly where to sew on the buttons.

#### NOTES TO KNIT BY . . .

#### STITCH AND ROW GAUGE

KNIT A SAMPLE SWATCH... before you begin to knit any garment... for this is the MOST IMPORTANT STEP toward the correct size and the proper fit of any garment you wish to make. You MUST use the SAME YARN for your sample swatch that you will use to knit your garment and your sample swatch must be knitted large enough and using several different tension numbers on your machine. When you have done this, then you can determine the number of stitches and the number of rows in a two-inch measure. KNITKING MAGAZINE PATTERNS give you 3 tensions to try and one of them should give you the correct stitch and row gauge if you are using the yarn we recommend or a similar weight yarn. Here is the way to make your sample swatch.

Cast on over a sufficient number of needles to produce a swatch at least 4 inches wide. (If the pattern calls for 16 stitches to 2", then  $16 \times 2 = 32$  stitches to cast on). Now knit 4 inches of rows at the first suggested tension number. (If the pattern calls for 22 rows to 2",  $22 \times 2 = 44$  rows to knit). Knit 2 rows using a contrast color, change to the next higher tension and with garment yarn knit another 4", knit 2 rows with contrast color, change to the 3rd higher tension and knit another 4" and then bind off.

Roll the swatch into a cylinder over its length and pull on both ends, unroll it and stretch it diagonally by pulling on the four corners. Allow the swatch to rest and settle (preferably overnight) and then using a stitch gauge or a ruler, count the number of stitches over a 2" width, then the number of rows over a 2" length in EACH of the 3 tensions. Select the tension number that produces the stitches and rows called for in the pattern. If none of them are correct, you are most likely using the wrong weight of yarn.

#### READING OF CHARTS

You will notice the instructions start at the bottom of the Chart, and work UP. Follow the charts exactly as written and providing your sample stitch and row gauge is correct, your garment will come out the right size. Please remember that the section of garment as it is knitted on the machine, faces the same way as the Charts are in this magazine. Where two front pieces are needed, (or any other part of a garment that needs two sections) only one section is normally shown and the second section is usually made with reverse shaping. Set in sleeves are usually identical, but raglan sleeves have to be knitted with reverse shaping for the second sleeve.

#### READING OF SYMBOLS

To simplify Pattern Knitting, we use Symbols in the Line Drawings and the Chart Diagrams. In the Line Drawings the symbols are shown and are to be read as you look at them while knitting a garment. For instance, if

a Purl stitch faces you, the Purl stitch Symbol is shown; if a knit stitch faces you (as when using the Ribber) then this Symbol is shown. The Symbol at the top of the Line Drawing is the center of the garment section and you use this as a guide for setting up the needles.

The following Symbols are used for Eyelet Designs in the Line Drawings and also for Full Fashion shaping on the Charts. The Line Drawings have row numbers on the right side. Missing Row numbers are always knitted straight or plain.

In Holding Position Designs

selected needles are pushed into holding position for the stated number of rows. The numbers of rows appear at the right of the Line Drawings; Example: 1–4 means knit Rows 1 to 4; 5 to 7 means knit Rows 5 to 7, etc. This same Symbol is also shown on the Charts and is used for putting needles into holding position for Short Rows. The

Symbol on the Charts is used to put needles back into working position when knitting Short Rows.

A number in a box stands for the number of rows to be knitted between shapings. Make shaping first, then knit the necessary number of rows. If for instance it reads:


1 st. 8 x

6 1 st. 10 x

As you will be reading the instructions from the bottom up, here is the way you will follow them: . . . Decrease or increase (depending on the direction of the garment outline) 1 st. at the row where the shaping begins, then knit 8 rows, make the next decrease, then knit 8 rows, until you have decreased (or increased) 1 st. 10 x and you have knitted 8 rows after each decrease (or increase) (1 st. 10 x +8 rows 10 x). Now begin the first decrease (or increase) for the shaping (which has to be made 8 x) in every 6th row. Decrease (or increase) 1 st. first, then knit 6 rows until you have decreased 1 st. 6 x and after each decrease (or increase) have knitted 6 rows (1 st. 8 x + 6 rows 8 x).

Where shapings are given without a boxed number as on most armholes, necklines, etc., make the shapings on every second row (on each side of course).
