Knit and crocheted vests are very popular at this time and in order to satisfy the many requests we have received from readers for instructions on how to make them we are including a bonus pattern in this issue.

The instructions are in KNITKING NEWS and when you study them you will notice that they cover a range of sizes but that the size is controlled by variations in the knitting tension . . . not by extra stitches and rows . . . and that the pattern stitch is lacy, allowing for blocking to most sizes.

Because the vest is so easy to make, we offer it to our readers as a lesson in size control through variations in stitch size, and we suggest that you experiment with the principle any time you wish to produce a KNITKING garment in a larger or smaller size than the instructions are written for.

As an example, we refer you to pattern DK 7804 in this issue . . . the width at the bottom of each section is 24½" . . . Allowing for seams, the finished circumference should be approximately 48". The instructions call for a yarn that produces 8 stitches to the inch, so $48 \times 8 = 348$ stitches . . . now if we set the tension control 1 tension higher (i.e., 6 to 7) the same yarn will knit at 7½ stitches to the inch and if you cast on the same number of stitches as called for in the instructions, the circumference at the bottom will be $384 \div 7.5 = 51"$. . . 3" larger than if it were one tension lower.

The finished underarm circumference is 38" at 8 stitches to the inch. When you increase the tension and get 7½ stitches to the inch, the underarm measurement will increase to 40½" . . . a size 16 . . . Simple, isn't it?

Of course, if you want the garment to be smaller than called for in the instructions, you set your tension control so that you get 8½ stitches per inch . . . the circumference under the arms will then become 36" and at the bottom a little over 45".


By just changing the stitch gauge through tension control and otherwise knitting exactly as stated, we have shown how the size of a garment can be varied to fit from a size 10 through 16 . . . you must not however, lose sight of the fact that when you alter your tension, you will also increase or decrease the length of the garment and will need to make an adjustment in the length of hem you turn. This is relatively easy on pattern DK 7804 because you have 72 rows to play with. For simplicity in shortening or lengthening a garment, you should always make the adjustments before decreases and increases start. For example, if you want to make DK 7804 longer, you can knit more rows at the bottom between 0 and 72, then reset your counter to 72 and continue the instructions exactly as shown.

You are, of course, restricted in the amount you can increase or decrease the tension for specific yarns. Don't try to make a size 12 garment into a size 20 by increasing the tension from 6 to 10. If you do, you will make your knitting too loose and sloppy.

SIZE: 12/14. **MATERIAL:** 24½ oz. (14 balls) white KNITKING Subita Crepe 2 x 4, Color No. 4. **TENSION:** KNITKING 6 to 8. STITCH GAUGE: PATTERN STITCH 14 sts. 2", 38 rows 2". **PATTERN:** Holding Position Design according to Line Drawing. The Gate Cam Release Lever of the Ribber is placed at the needle heels. EDGES: K1, P1, Ribbing. Be sure to replace the Lever of the Ribber after completing each section. NECKLINE DECREASES: After Rows indicated, hang the 1st st. ON NECK SIDE onto the 2nd st. SLEEVE INCREASES: After rows indicated, ON EACH SIDE place the 1st st. from the row below onto the next empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections to measurements given. Join front and back sections at sides and shoulders, easing in the fullness at bustline of front sections. Sew sleeves together and set in. Sew bands together, then sew bands to front edges and neckline. Sew pockets in place.

CENTER OF GARMENT SECTION ▶




Bring the needles on the left side back into working position according to the PATTERN, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 516 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * . Count the extra Row for the Holding Position Design.

* ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Row 516 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING): 8 sts. (7 sts. for the left half) after Row 517 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING): 8 sts. (8 sts. 2 sts. after Row 518; 3 sts. after Row 519; 2 sts. after Row 520; 3 sts. after Row 521; 2 sts. after Rows 522, 523, 524, 525, 526, 527; 3 sts. after Row 528; 2 sts. after Row 529; 3 sts. after Row 530).

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 500, 501, 502, 503, 504, 505, 506, 507, 508, 509, 510, 511, 512, 513, 514, 515, then knit to Row 516, put 39 needles on the left side into holding position (transfer the ribber sts.) and complete the right half first.

ROWS 23 to 348: Knit even. ROWS 0 to 22: Knit even, then set up for PATTERN, place the Gate Cam Release Lever of the Ribber at the needle heels and work the Holding Position Design.



ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 22, (keep in PATTERN) 36, 50, 64, 78, 92, 106, 120, 134, 148, 162, 176, 190, 204, 218, 232, 246, 260, 274, 288, then knit to Row 302.


ROW 0 to 22: Knit even, then set up for PATTERN, place the Gate Cam Release Lever of the Ribber at the needle heels and work the Holding Position Design. Cast on 67 sts. and work K1, P1, Ribbing.


Work the second front section with reverse shapings. Cast on the regular way. Knit 22 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then transfer the appropriate ribber sts. to the main machine, place the Gate Cam Release Lever of the Ribber at the needle heels, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to Row 22 and work the Holding Position Design. Follow the instructions from * .

ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Row 363 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING), then decrease 1 st. ON CAM BOX SIDE after Rows in (). ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Row 364 (EVEN ROWS = ARMHOLE SHAPING); 3 sts. after Rows 368, 372; (375), 2 sts. after Rows 376, 380, 384; (387), 1 st. after Rows 388, 392. The Armhole is now completed. Continue to decrease 1 st. for Neck Shaping after Rows 399, 411, 423, 435, 447, 459, 471, 483, 495, 507, then decrease 1 st. on NECK SIDE after Rows in (), Knit to Row 516. For SHOULDER, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 516, 518, (519), 520, 522, 524, 526, 528, 530, (531 last time for Neck), 532, 534, 536, 538, 540, 542; 3 sts. after Rows 544, 546. (Place the Lever of the Ribber back to the needle heads.)

* ROWS 23 to 363: Knit even. ROWS 0 to 22: Knit even, then set up for PATTERN, place the Gate Cam Release Lever of the Ribber to the needle heels and work the Holding Position Design.


Cast on 67 sts. and work K1, P1, Ribbing.





DK 7800

Cast on 43 sts, set up for PATTERN, Ribber at the needle heels and work 90 rows in Holding Position Design, then transfer the appropriate sts. to the Ribber, replace the Rubber Lever and work 10 rows K1, P1, Ribbing. After Row 100 bind off all sts. the crochet method for ribbing.





Cast on 167 sts, and work 14 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all sts. the crochet method for ribbing.



Cast on 109 sts, and work 14 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all sts. the crochet method for ribbing.

SIZE: 12/14. **MATERIAL:** Slacks 15½ oz. (9 balls), Shell 12½ oz. (7 balls) red KNITKING Subita Crepe 2 x 3, Color No. 115, TENSION: KNITKING 3 to 5. **STITCH GAUGE:** Stockinette Stitch 18 sts. 2" / 24 rows 2". Pattern Stitch 20 sts. 2" / 28 rows 2". **PATTERN:** Slacks Stockinette Stitch; Shell Purl 3, Knit 1, Ribbing according to Line Drawing. Make all shapings of 1 st. on the Slacks Full-fashion. **DECREASES:** After Rows indicated, hang the 3rd st. on the appropriate sides onto the 2nd st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. **INCREASES:** After Rows indicated, move the 2 end sts. on the appropriate side 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below outward, then place the 3rd st. from the DARTS by hanging together the sts. marked on the diagram, then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needles. The following decreases for the Darts lie directly above. The finished length of the instep seam is 28¼".

FINISHING: Block all sections to measurements given. **SLACKS:** Join front and back sections at center back, then join center fronts about 4". Make a narrow hem around the opening. Sew in a zipper. Turn under 12 rows on upper edge and 20 rows on leg edges and hem to wrong side. Insert an elastic band into upper hem. Finish the button-hole, sew on a button. **SHELL:** Join front and back section at sides and shoulders, easing in the fullness at bustline of front section. Turn under a small amount around armholes and hem to wrong side. Join short ends of collar. Sew 1 edge of collar to inside and 1 edge to outside of neckline.



Cast on 167 sts, and work 14 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all sts. the crochet method for ribbing.

Cast on 109 sts, and work 14 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all sts. the crochet method for ribbing.

Work the second back section with reverse shapings, casting on from right to left. (Cam Box will be on the LEFT SIDE at Row 0).

Work Short Rows for the shaping of the ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX, put into holding position 7 needles after Rows 500, 502, 504, 506, 508, after Rows 510, 512. After Row 514 bring all needles back into working position, knit even to Row 538, then bind off the remaining 67 sts.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX decrease 1 st. for SIDE SEAM and 2 sts. for each DART after Row 442, then repeat these decreases after Rows in (). ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 444, 452, (456), 460, 468, (470), 476, 484, (484), 492, (498), then knit to Row 500.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX increase 1 st. after Rows 366, 368, (363), 370; 3 sts. after Rows 372, 374; 2 sts. after Rows 376, 378, 380, (380), 382; 1 st. after Rows 384, 386, 388, 390, 392, (392), 394, 396, 400, 404, (404) (inCREASE), 408, 412, 420, 428, 436, then knit to Row 442.








UP TO ROW 404, INCREASE 1 st. ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX AFTER ROWS IN (). ON CAM BOX SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 198, (198), (206), 212, (214), (222), 226, (230), (238), 240, (246), 248, (254), 256, (262), 264, (270), 272, (278), 280, (286), 288, (294), (294), 300, (302), 306, (310), 312, 318, (318), 324, (328), 330, 336, (338), 342, 344, 346, 348, (348), 350, 352, 354, 356, 358, (358), 360, 362, then knit to Row 366.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 40, 70, 100, 130, then knit even to Row 198.

ROWS 0 to 40: Knit even.

Cast on 94 sts, and work stockinette st.





SIZE: 10/12. **MATERIAL:** Skirt 12½ oz. (7 balls) white; Jacket 5½ oz. (3 balls) white, 3½ oz. (2 balls) purple and 3½ oz. (2 balls) lilac KNITTING Subita Crepe 2 x 3. Color Nos. 104, 136 and 141. **TENSION:** KNITTING 4 to 6. STITCH GAUGE: 17 sts. 2", 24 rows 2". **PATTERN:** Stockinette Stitch with repeated color stripes on the jacket section as marked in the diagram of the back section. **DECREASES:** K1, P1, Ribbing. SKIRT and NECKLINE DECREASES: After Rows indicated, hang the 4th st. on the appropriate sides onto the 3rd st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. **SLEEVE INCREASES:** After rows indicated, move the 2 end sts. ON EACH SIDE 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below onto the empty needle. The finished length of the skirt is 20¾".

FINISHING: Block all sections to measurements given. **SKIRT:** Weave the sections together, 1st in on each edge. Turn under 2" at lower edge and 1" at upper edge and hem to wrong side. Insert an elastic band into upper hem. **JACKET:** Join front and back sections at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Sew bands together, then sew band to front edges and neckline. Finish buttonholes, sew on buttons.



Cast on 144 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing. Make buttonholes after Row 8 over the sts. marked on the diagram. After Row 16 bind off all sts. Work the button band the same, but omit the buttonholes.

Work 3 more sections the same.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 76, 86, 96, 106, 116, 126, 136, 146, 156, 166, 176, 186, 196, 206, 216, 226, 236, 246, 256, 266, then knit to Row 290 and bind off the remaining 62 sts.

ROWS 0 to 76: Knit even.

Cast on 102 sts. and work stockinette st. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 16, 22, 28, 34, 40, then knit to Row 50.

ROWS 0 to 16: Knit even, then transfer the ribber sts. to the main machine, change to purple and work the repeated color stripes.

Cast on 109 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 286 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

- * ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Row 286 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING): 8 sts. (7 sts. for the left half) after Row 287 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING): 4 sts. after Rows 288, 289, 290, 291; 5 sts. after Row 292; 4 sts. after Row 293; 3 sts. after Row 294; 3 sts. after Row 295; 5 sts. after Row 296; 3 sts. after Row 297; 5 sts. after Rows 298, 300.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 5 sts. after Row 194, 195; 4 sts. after Rows 196, 197, 198, 199; 2 sts. after Rows 200, 201, 202, 203; 1 st. after Rows 204, 205, 206, 207. Now knit to Row 286, then put 62 needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ROWS 17 to 194: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 16: Knit even, then transfer the ribber sts. to the main machine, change to purple and work the repeated color stripes.

Cast on 163 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 5 sts. after Row 194, 195; 4 sts. after Rows 196, 197, 198, 199; 2 sts. after Rows 200, 201, 202, 203; 1 st. after Rows 204, 205, 206, 207. Now knit to Row 288, then put 62 needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ROWS 17 to 194: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 16: Knit even, then transfer the ribber sts. to the main machine, change to purple and work the repeated color stripes.

Cast on 163 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Row 194, 195; 3 sts. after Rows 196, 197, 198, 199; 2 sts. after Rows 200, 201, 202, 203; 1 st. after Rows 204, 205, 206, 207. Now knit to Row 286, then put 62 needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ROWS 17 to 194: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 16: Knit even, then transfer the ribber sts. to the main machine, change to purple and work the repeated color stripes.

Cast on 77 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

Work the second front section with reverse shapings, casting on from right to left. (Cam Box will be on the LEFT SIDE at Row 0.)




ON CAM BOX SIDE after Rows 207, 211, 215, 219, 223, 227, 231, 235, 241, 247, 253, 259, 265, 271, 277, 283, then again 1 st. after Rows in (), For SHOULDER R, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 286, 288, (289), 290, 5 sts. after Rows 292, 294, (295), 296, 298, 300.

ROWS 17 to 194: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 16: Knit even, then transfer the ribber sts. to the main machine, change to purple and work the repeated color stripes.

Cast on 77 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 6 sts. after Rows 50, 51; 4 sts. after Rows 52, 53, 54; 2 sts. after Rows 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 60; 61: ON EACH SIDE, hang the 1st st. onto the 2nd st. after Rows 62, 64, 66, 68, 70, 72, 74, 76, 78, 80, 82, 84, 86, 88, 90, 92, 94, 96, 98, 100, 102. ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 104, 105, 106, 107; 3 sts. after Rows 108, 109; 5 sts. after Row 110, 111; 13 sts. after Row 112.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 16, 22, 28, 34, 40, then knit to Row 50.

ROWS 0 to 16: Knit even, then transfer the ribber sts. to the main machine, change to purple and work the repeated color stripes.

Cast on 109 sts. with white and work K1, P1, Ribbing.



KNITTING: Stockinette Stitch 17 sts. to 5. STITCH GAUGE: Stockinette Stitch 17 sts. 2", 30 rows 2". **PATTERN:** Stockinette Stitch and an Eyelet Design according to Line Drawing. Make all shapings of 1 st. Full-fashion. **DECREASES:** After Rows indicated, hang the 4th st. on the appropriate sides onto the 3rd st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. **INCREASES:** After Rows indicated, move the 2 end sts. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 58, 66, 74. Now knit to Row 82, change to white and work the repeated color stripes. Continue to decrease 1 st. ON EACH SIDE after Rows 82, 90, 98, then knit even to Row 126.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34. ON CAM BOX SIDE, cast on 2 sts. after Rows 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 3 sts. after Rows 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55; 6 sts. after Rows 56, 57, then knit to Row 58.

ROWS 0 to 24: Knit even.

Cast on 26 sts. with red and work stockinette st.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 50, 56, 62, 68, 74, 80, 86, 92, then knit to Row 98.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 2, 8, 14, 20, then increase 1 st. ON EACH SIDE after Rows 26, 32, 38, 44. After Row 46 form the hem, then change to blue and knit to Row 50.

Cast on 130 sts. with white and work stockinette st.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 214 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

* ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 5 sts. after Row 215 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 3 sts. after Rows 217, 219; 2 sts. after Rows 221, 223; 1 st. after Rows 225, 227, 229, 231. Now knit to Row 270, then bind off the remaining 10 sts.


ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 192, 193, 194, 195; 2 sts. after Rows 196, 197, 198, 199, 200; 1 st. after Rows 202, 203, 204, 205, 206, 207. Now knit to Row 214, then put 29 sts. on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 126, 146, 166, then knit even to Row 190.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 58, 66, 74. Now knit to Row 82, change to white and work the repeated color stripes. Continue to decrease 1 st. ON EACH SIDE after Rows 82, 90, 98, then knit even to Row 126.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36. ON CAM BOX SIDE, cast on 2 sts. after Rows 38, 39, 40, 41, 42, 43, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 51, 52, 53, 54, 55, 56, 57, then knit to Row 58.

Cast on 26 sts. with red and work stockinette st.





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

SIZE: 7-8. **MATERIAL:** 1½ oz. (1 ball) blue, 1¾ oz. (1 ball) gold and 1½ oz. (1 ball) red KNIT-KING Subta Dralon 3 ply, Color Nos. 417, 435 and 427. **TENSION:** KNITTING 4 to 6, STITCH GAUGE: 16 sts. 2", 24 rows 2". **PATTERN:** Stockinette Stitch and repeated color stripes as marked in the diagram. **BELT** and **LOOPS:** K1, P1, Ribbing. To form the hem, hang the cast-on sts. back on the machine behind the latches, then knit the following row with 2 tension settings higher.

FINISHING: Block the sections to measurements given. (Subtract the hem depth). Join front and back section at sides and weave the sts. for the crotch together. Turn under a small amount at leg edges, hem to wrong side and insert elastic bands. Insert an elastic band into upper hem. Sew loops in place.



Cast on 15 sts. with blue and work 240 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all




Cast on 9 sts. with blue and work 12 rows K1, P1, Ribbing, then bind off all sts.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 1 st. after Rows 76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85, 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, 101, 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109, 110, 111, 112, 113; 2 sts. after Rows 114, 115, 116, 117, 118, 119, 120, 121, 122, 123, 124, 125, 126, 127, 128, 129. After Row 130 put the remaining 32 sts. on a stitch holder.

Work Short Rows for the shaping of the back. On OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX put into holding position 8 needles after Rows 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37. Knit to Row 38, change to gold, work the repeated color stripes as marked in the diagram of the front section AND ON OPPOSITE SIDE of CAM BOX, bring all needles back into working position after Rows 38, 39, then knit to Row 76.

ROWS 0 to 28: Knit even to Row 27, then form the hem and knit 1 row. After Row 28 change to gold and work the repeated color stripes as marked in the diagram.

Cast on 102 sts. with blue and work stockinette st.




ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 6 sts. after Rows 66, 67, 3 sts. after Rows 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73, 2 sts. after Rows 74, 75, 76, 77, 78, 79, 80, 81, 82, 83, 84, 85; 1 st. after Rows 86, 87, 88, 89, 90, 91, 92, 93, 94, 95, 96, 97, 98, 99, 100, 101. Now knit to Row 120, then put the remaining 32 sts. on a stitch holder.

ROWS 29 to 66: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 28: Knit even to Row 27, then form the hem and knit 1 row. After Row 28 change to gold and work the repeated color stripes as marked in the diagram.

Cast on 102 sts. with blue and work stockinette st.



ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Row 152 (EVEN ROWS = ARM-HOLE SHAPING); 5 sts. after Row 153 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 4 sts. after Row 154; 3 sts. after Rows 155, 156, 157; 2 sts. after Rows 158, 159, 160, 161, 1 st. after Rows 162, 163, 164, 165, 166, 167, 169. Now knit to Row 198, then bind off the remaining 13 sts.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 48, 54, 60, 66, 72, 78, 84, 90, 102, 108, 114, 120, 126, 132, 138. Now knit to Row 152, put 50 needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ROWS 0 to 48: Knit even.

Cast on 132 sts. and work stockinette st.

SIZE: 3-4, (Chest 22"-23"). **MATERIAL:** 5¼ oz. (3 balls) red KNITTING Subta Dralon 3 ply, Color No. 436. **TENSION:** 4 to 6, STITCH GAUGE: 16 sts. 2", 23 rows 2". **PATTERN:** Stockinette Stitch. Make all decreases of 1 st. Full-fashion. After Rows indicated, hang the 3rd st. on the appropriate side onto the 2nd st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block the sections to measurements given. Join front and back section at sides. Turn under 2" on lower edge and hem to wrong side. Work 2 rows of single crochet around all upper edges. Sew a large snap to each shoulder for closure. Sew a button to the shaped ends of back straps. Turn under 3/4" on upper edge of pocket and hem to wrong side. Sew an animal figure to pocket, then sew pocket to center of dress (see picture).






Material: 1 3/4 oz. (1 ball) each of 3 colors; main color, contrast color and black KNIT KING Sonika Draalon, 12" diameter Pillow Form, 3 inches thick; 12" zipper. Tension: 7 or 8. Gauge: 14 sts., 19 rows 2".

FINISHING: Weave together the sections held on contrast waste yarn, then remove waste yarn. Pull pieces into shape. Put the black edging around the outside edge of Pillow form, then pin zipper in smoothly. Remove the edging and sew the zipper in with straight edge against the zipper, the other side with 3 extra stitches overlapping the zipper to cover it. Catch down the 3 sts. held on stitch holder. Put the black edges back onto pillow form and smooth evenly. Pin the top sections to the black edging on each side making sure it is even, then weave together 1 st. in from each edge. Run a strand of yarn around center edges and pull up tightly and secure. Make a flower to put on the plain side.


ROWS 204-384: Put all needles into work and knit even. Remove on contrast waste yarn.

ROWS 91-203: After ROW 91 cast on 3 sts. To do this, put 3 sts. from left section onto a stitch holder then cast on. Now knit even. After ROW 203, put Row Counter back to 90, all needles on the right side into holding position. Put all needles on the left into working position, put the 3 sts. held on stitch holder back on machine by removing 3 sts. on right side to a stitch holder and knit even to Row 203.

ROWS 1-90: Knit even, then put 11 sts. on the left side into holding position and knit the right side first.

EDGING: Open cast on 21 sts., then change to black yarn.


ROWS 33-383: Change to contrast color and REPEAT ROWS 1-32 11 times more, changing color after each section but ending with only 3 rows of black at the end of the last section instead of 4. Leave a long strand for weaving and break yarn. Knit several rows with waste yarn and remove work from machine. Make a second section the same as above using MAIN COLOR ONLY.

ROWS 29-32: Change to black and put all needles into working position, then knit even.

ROWS 1-28: On the LEFT side and on EVERY OTHER ROW, put 3 needles into holding position 13 x and 2 needles 1 x. DO NOT WRAP THE YARN around the needles in holding position — the hole is part of design.

Cast-on 43 sts. using contrast waste yarn. After knitting several rows and with Cam Box on the left side, then knit 1 row to the right with a ravel cord. Change to main color.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 180 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from .



* ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 5 sts. after Row 181 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 3 sts. after Rows 183, 185; 2 sts. after Rows 187, 189; 1 st. after Rows 191, 193, 195, 197. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 218, 220, 222, 224. After Row 226 bind off the remaining 5 sts.

Now knit even to Row 180, then put 32 needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 48, 54, 60, 66, 72, 78, 84, 90, 96, 102, 108, 114, 120, 126, 132, 138, then knit to Row 152.

ROWS 0 to 48: Knit even.

Cast on 132 sts. and work stockinette st.

KG 1907

Material: 1 3/4 oz. each of 6 different colors (6 balls) KNITTING Sonika Draalon, 1 Pillow Form 12", diameter, 2 inches thick. Tension: 7 or 8. Gauge: 14 sts. 19 rows 2".

FINISHING: Weave together the sts. held on contrast yarn a little more than half way across, then put in the pillow form and complete the weaving of sts. Run a strand of yarn around each center and pull up. Make a covered button or a flower for each center and attach.

CHANGE COLOR and REPEAT ROWS 1-60 5 times more (6 sections) each time changing color after 60 rows. Knit several rows with contrast waste yarn and remove work from machine.

ROWS 37-60: Put 3 sts. opposite Cam Box back into working position beginning each row.


ROWS 31-36: Put 2 sts. opposite Cam Box back into working position beginning each row.

ROWS 25-30: Put 2 sts. opposite Cam Box into holding position beginning each row (short rows — be sure to wrap the yarn around end needle in holding position).




(1 ball) white KNITTING Subita Dralon 2 ply, Color Nos. 416, 410, 406 and 401 TENSION: KNITTING 1 to 2. STITCH GAUGE: 19 sts. 2", 30 rows 2". PATTERN: Stockinette Stitch and repeated color stripes as marked in the diagram. NECKBAND: K1, P1, Ribbing. To form the hem, hang the cast-on sts. back on the machine behind the latches. (Knit the following row with 2 tension settings higher). SLEEVE INCREASES: After rows indicated, move the 2 end sts. ON EACH SIDE 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections to measurements given. (Subtract the hem depth). Join front and back section at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Join neckband sections at short ends. Sew 1 edge of neckband to inside and 1 edge to outside of neckline, matching front and back section.

OUR READERS WRITE

"I never know what SIZE garment to knit. Nothing is ever exactly my size and I don't know how to change directions to fit me!!!"

You are not alone.... No one is really a perfect size 10 or 12 or 14.... You might be a size 10 upstairs, and a size 14 downstairs...or the sizes might be in reverse... What can you do?

The garment and pattern industries comply to Standards for Body Measurements... The amount of ease allowed on their garments will vary and depend on several things... the material used such as heavy or light, soft or stiff... whether it will be an outer garment such as a Jacket or Cardigan or a Pullover Sweater, Blouse, Dress, etc., etc.

You are indeed fortunate when you can knit your own garments and made the necessary changes so that it will really fit you no matter what size you wear. When you knit a garment from KNITKING MAGAZINE, you can change the measurements easily. We cannot give directions for making each garment in many sizes because it is not possible to include all the figures for shaping, fashioning, etc., in each chart. Our new Charts make it very easy to alter the size. At a glance you can see the actual number of stitches to bind off at Armhole, Shoulder and Neckline as well as the number of rows between points of shaping. The measurements shown on the Charts are the actual blocking measurements.

One of the best ways to decide what size to knit is to compare the measurements shown on KNITKING MAGAZINE Charts with the measurements taken from a dress or a sweater or a jacket that you own and that fits you well. Again we repeat... our measurements on the Charts are BLOCKING MEASUREMENTS. If there is only a slight difference between the actual measurements shown and your own measurements taken from your dress or sweater, you can go ahead and knit that garment providing of course that you have made a stitch and row gauge sample and it complies with the stitch and row gauge given in our pattern. Please make a rough sketch of the chart and put in YOUR measurements... If there is a difference of 1" on the front and 1" on the back, you can cast on 1" MORE of stitches for a LARGER size, or 1" LESS stitches for a SMALLER size. Make the necessary adjustments by dividing the extra amounts of stitches for a larger size between the armholes, shoulders and if necessary the neckline. Bind off the extra stitches at the armhole by knitting 1 or 2 extra bind-off rows. Bind off the extra stitches at shoulders by adding them to the last shoulder bind-off. If you have extra stitches at neckline, take them off at the first neck bind-off. For the smaller size... reverse the procedure. You will bind off LESS stitches at armhole, shoulder and neckline.

Make all shapings up to the armhole as given in the instructions. Change your length if you like, by subtracting or adding rows where there is EVEN KNITTING, then ALWAYS put your Row Counter to the row where shapings begin, thus making it easy for you to make your shapings on the rows as given in the pattern.

Some people think that because they have the same yarn the pattern calls for, they can sit down and make a garment without making a test sample swatch ... NEVER under any circumstances do this... the most important part of your knitting is your sample swatch. We give you several tensions to try out because machine tensions will vary and the dye used in yarns can make a difference so that one color will give you the stitch and row gauge on one tension, while another color will give you the stitch and row gauge on another tension...so don't forget, if you want perfect garments, making a sample swatch using 3 different tensions is the most important part of your knitting.

So the RULE IS:... You must get the EXACT stitch and row gauge as shown in our patterns if you want them to turn out exactly to the measurements shown (the blocked measurements) and if our sample garment was made with Tension 5 and gives 16 sts. to 2" and 21 rows to 2", but you get the same stitch and row gauge on Tension 6 or perhaps 7, use whatever tension(for that particular garment) that will give you the number of stitches and rows called for in the pattern regardless of what tension number you get it on...

For a simple method of increasing or reducing the sizes of garments in KNITKING MAGAZINE, be sure to read the "Letter from the Publisher" in this issue.

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

When working a Pattern with a Holding Position Design, it takes a specific number of rows to obtain a Pattern Set. When working a Pattern in Fisherman's Rib, one has to knit 2 rows - from right to left, then from left to right, to obtain 1 visible row. As you know, all our Line Drawings for Holding Position Designs are written to be set up and be started from right to left. When knitting a garment that has 2 front sections such as Jackets or Dresses with a front closure, the second front section has to be worked with reverse shapings.




To enable you to follow the instructions as written, we make you start this section on the left side (Cam Box on the left side and Row Counter at 0). To obtain the same pattern picture (Holding Position Designs) as on the first section, you have to cast on from left to right, the same as for the first section. If the garment has a ribbed or plain band, knit the band then set up your needles for your specific pattern stitch and knit 1 row in PATTERN STITCH to the left side.

Now you must turn your Row Counter back 1 row so your Row Counter shows even numbers when you are on the left side. This extra row will not make any difference in the length of the section, but must be counted as one row in your pattern stitch set. ALWAYS knit the pattern from right to left and set your needle positions from right to left. ...This also applies when finishing the left half of a section.


KNITTED LACE VEST

Size: Small (fits Bust 32 - 34), Medium (fits Bust 36 - 38), Large (fits Bust 40 - 42). Material: Small and Medium 7 oz. (4 balls); Large 8 3/4 oz. (5 balls) KNITKING Sonika Dralon. Tension: Small: Tension 7 to 8; Medium: Tension 8 to 9; Large: Tension 9 to 10. Gauge: Tension 7 to 8: 14 sts. 2", 20 rows 2". The higher tension setting will produce a looser stitch which can then be blocked into the larger sizes. Pattern: Holding Position Design with omitted needles according to Line Drawing. The purl side is the right side. The omitted needles in the pattern are counted as stitches in the Stitch Gauge and Instructions. Empty needles are counted as sts. when shaping. When binding off be sure to make 2 chain sts. where there are empty needles.

FINISHING: Pin each section to measurements, then dampen and let dry (do not use iron). Join front and back sections at sides and shoulders. Work 1 row of single crochet around all edges and armholes, then one row as follows: Chain 1, *single crochet in next 5 single crochets, chain 4, slip stitch into top of single crochet where chain 4 is (picot made). REPEAT from * around. Make cord for tie.



BONUS PATTERN



ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 14 sts. after Rows 234, 235; 11 sts. after Rows 236, 237; 7 sts. after Rows 238, 239. After Row 240 bind off remaining 43 sts.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 21 sts. after Rows 150, 151, then knit to Row 234.

ROWS 0 to 150: Knit even.

Bring 149 needles into working position, then set up according to the Line Drawing, knit 2 rows stockinette st., turn the Row Counter back to 0 and work the Holding Position Design.

Work the second front section with reverse shaping, casting on from right to left. (Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0) Begin Pattern by putting second single needle on the left side into holding position.

On OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX (Neck side), decrease 1 st. after Rows 150, 152, 154, 156, 158, 160, 162, 164, 166, 168, 170, 172, 174, 176, 178, 180, 182, 184, then continue to decrease 1 st. ON NECK SIDE after Rows 187, 190, 193, 196, 199, 202, 205, 208, 211, 214, 217, 220, 223, 226. For SHOULDER, bind off 14 sts. after Row 234; 11 sts. after Row 236; 8 sts. after Row 238.

ROWS 0 to 150: Knit even, then bind off 21 sts. ON CAM BOX SIDE for armhole.

Bring 86 needles into working position, then set up according to Line Drawing, knit 2 rows stockinette st., turn the Row Counter back to 0 and work the Holding Position Design. Begin pattern by putting the second single needle on the right into holding position first.

NOTES TO KNIT BY . . .

STITCH AND ROW GAUGE

KNIT A SAMPLE SWATCH . . . before you begin to knit any garment . . . for this is the MOST IMPORTANT STEP toward the correct size and the proper fit of any garment you wish to make. You MUST use the SAME YARN for your sample swatch that you will use to knit your garment and your sample swatch must be knitted large enough and using several different tension numbers on your machine. When you have done this, then you can determine the number of stitches and the number of rows in a two-inch measure. KNITKING MAGAZINE PATTERNS give you 3 tensions to try and one of them should give you the correct stitch and row gauge if you are using the yarn we recommend or a similar weight yarn. Here is the way to make your sample swatch.

Cast on over a sufficient number of needles to produce a swatch at least 4 inches wide. (If the pattern calls for 16 stitches to 2", then $16 \times 2 = 32$ stitches to cast on). Now knit 4 inches of rows at the first suggested tension number. (If the pattern calls for 22 rows to 2", $22 \times 2 = 44$ rows to knit). Knit 2 rows using a contrast color, change to the next higher tension and with garment yarn knit another 4", knit 2 rows with contrast color, change to the 3rd higher tension and knit another 4" and then bind off.

Roll the swatch into a cylinder over its length and pull on both ends, unroll it and stretch it diagonally by pulling on the four corners. Allow the swatch to rest and settle (preferably overnight) and then using a stitch gauge or a ruler, count the number of stitches over a 2" width, then the number of rows over a 2" length in EACH of the 3 tensions. Select the tension number that produces the stitches and rows called for in the pattern. If none of them are correct, you are most likely using the wrong weight of yarn.

READING OF CHARTS

You will notice the instructions start at the bottom of the Chart and work UP. Follow the charts exactly as written and providing your sample stitch and row gauge is correct, your garment will come out the right size. Please remember that the section of garment as it is knitted on the machine, faces

the same way as the Charts are in this magazine. Where two front pieces are needed, (or any other part of a garment that needs two sections) only one section is normally shown and the second section is sometimes made with reverse shaping. Set in sleeves are usually identical, but raglan sleeves have to be knitted with reverse shaping for the second sleeve.

READING OF SYMBOLS

Symbols are used on Line Drawings of Pattern stitches to show the position of the needles and the variety of stitches used for Pattern knitting. These Symbols are drawn and are to be read as you look at them while knitting the garment. For instance: if a Purl stitch faces you, the Purl stitch Symbol  is shown; if a knit stitch faces you (as when using the ribber) then this Symbol  is shown. The Line Drawings for pattern stitches are to be read and set up on your machine from RIGHT to LEFT unless otherwise stated in the individual instructions.

In EYELET design Patterns    specified stitches are transferred to an adjacent needle and the empty needles are returned to the working position. The drawings have row numbers on the RIGHT side. Missing Row Numbers are ALWAYS knitted straight or plain.

In HOLDING POSITION DESIGNS  selected needles are pushed into holding position for the stated number of rows. The numbers of rows appear at the right of the Line Drawings. Example: 1-4 means knit rows 1 to 4; 5-7 means knit rows 5 to 7; 8-12 means knit rows 8 to 12, etc. etc. (See below for more Pattern Stitch Symbols.)

BLOCKING and ASSEMBLING GARMENTS

Block each section of your knitting separately BEFORE assembling any garment. This not only makes putting your garment together much easier but gives it that professional look of perfection. For the correct assembly of garments and all other important information regarding machine knitting, refer to our book "Practical Knitting Hints."

PATTERN STITCH SYMBOLS

-  = knit stitch
-  = purl stitch
-  = empty needle (leave in working position)
-  = needle not used (in the out of work position)

-  = needle in the holding position
-  = 2 stitches on 1 needle – either transferred from the right side or the left side, then put the needle into holding position
-  = needle holding 2 stitches. Stitch has been transferred from the LEFT

-  = needle holding 2 stitches. Stitch has been transferred from the RIGHT
-  = 3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 needles has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

The diagrams (Line Drawings) for pattern work are followed just as they are shown and are to be read as you look at them while knitting the garment.
