












Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1 means decrease (or increase) 1 , knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows, decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.

General Instructions

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS ISSUE

FULL FASHION DECREASING AND INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for decreasing or increasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch, then move the stitches in

to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the trip control lever so that only 1 row registers.

TO MAKE FRINGE

Cut yarn DOUBLE the length of fringe desired (wind around a cardboard or book). Using 2 or more strands of yarn (depending on weight of yarn) fold in half and with a crochet hook, draw folded loop through knitting from the wrong side. Pull strands through loop and tighten.

To make an additional row of knots on fringe, take half the strands from 1 group and half from the next group, then knot together approximately 1" to 2" below and continue across.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a Cardigan or Jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 Tension Numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows WITHOUT actually counting, by using our KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast-on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn, then remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the figuring for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn. Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy..? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.



FINISHING: See General Instructions. Ease the extra rows at the bustline of front section of Coat.



Bring 134 (144) [156] needles into working position, set into Pattern then cast on over the remaining needles. Work in Holding Position Design with Tension 10 to Row 60. Change to Tension 9 and ON EACH SIDE decrease 1 st. every 24th row 6x, changing to Tension 8 after Row 120. After Row 180, change to Tension 7 and ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 8th row 4x, every 6th row 6x. Knit to Row 264. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 12th row 5x. Knit to Row 328.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3.sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x]. Knit to Row 396 (400) [404]. Bind off the center 16 sts. put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. Bind off FOR SHOULDER: 3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 5x (4 sts. 6x, 5 sts. 1x) [4 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 5x]. FOR NECK: All Sizes 2 sts. 5x.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 396 (400) [404] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




COAT FRONT: I -Make 1, reverse 1.


Bring 63 (68) [74] needles into working position, set into Pattern then cast on over the remaining needles. Work in Holding Position Design with Tension 10 to Row 60. Change to Tension 9 and ON CAM BOX SIDE decrease 1 st. every 24th row 6x. After Row 180, decrease 1 st. ON CAM BOX SIDE every 8th row 4x, every 6th row 1x. Knit to Row 264. ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 12th row 6x. Knit to Row 336 (340) [344].

SHAPE ARMHOLE: Bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x) [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x]. Knit to Row 385 (393) [401].

Bind off for NECK — All Sizes: 5 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 2x. SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 396 (400) [404]. Bind off 3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 5x. (4 sts. 6x, 5 sts. 1x). [4 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 5x].







176 Cast on 116 (132) [150] sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stich. Knit even to Row 20. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 4x, every 6th row 5x. Knit to Row 84.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: On each side bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x. (3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x]. Knit to Row 156 (164) [168]. Bind off the center 30 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. Bind off FOR SHOULDER: 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 4x. (4 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 3x). [5 sts. 5x]. FOR NECK: ALL SIZES: 3 sts. 3x.

Bring the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 156 (164) [168] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



BODICE FRONT: I


Work the front section the same as the back to Row 72 (68) [64] then work Short Rows for the BUST DART.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX ON EACH SIDE, put into holding position 6 sts. 6x (5 sts. 8x). [4 sts. 10x]. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring all the needles back into working position before knitting the next 2 rows. Knit to Row 96 (100) [104].

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5 x. SHAPE NECK AFTER ROW 108. (3sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x). (SHAPE NECK AFTER ROW 112). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x]. [SHAPE NECK AFTER ROW 116]. Bind off the center 20 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

*ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 6x. SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 168 (180) [188]. Bind off 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 4x. (4 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 3x). [5 sts. 5x].

Bring the Cam Box to the left side, turn to Row Counter back to 108 (112) [116] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.






Pring 46 (52) [60] needles into working position, then set into Pattern. Cast on over the remaining needles with color 1 with color changes as shown on the Chart. ON EACH SIDE, after Row 6, increase 1 st. every 6th row 8x, every 4th row 12x.

AFTER Row 102, SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, *1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x and REPEAT from * 4x more. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, *1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x and REPEAT from * 5x more). [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, *1 st. 1x, 2 sts. 1x and REPEAT from * 6x more]. ON EACH SIDE for all sizes, bind off 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, then bind off the remaining 8 sts.







*ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 5x, every 4th row 18x and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 258. (every 2nd row 5x, every 4th row 18x and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 262). [every 2nd row 11x, every 4th row 22x and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 266]. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 3 sts. 6x, 4 sts. 2x. (3 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 5x). [4 sts. 8x].

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 190 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.





SKIRT: V: Make 4 sections.

Cast on 123 (129) [135] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 38, hang the hem then knit to Row 58. Decrease 2 sts. for DART and 1 st. ON EACH SIDE at the same time, every 14th row 9x, every 16th row 3x. FOR THE DART decreases, the first time hang the 60th (63rd) [66th] st. ON EACH SIDE onto the 61st (64th) [67th] needles and move the sts. in to fill the empty needles. The following DART decreases lie directly above. After Row 230, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 8th row 10x, every 6th row 2x. After Row 340, bind off the remaining 51 (57) [63] sts.



NECKBAND: VIII

Cast on 157 (163) [169] sts. with color 2 and work K1, P1 Ribbing, Change to color 1 after Row 4 and ON EVERY OTHER ROW ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. 12x. After Row 26, bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



Coat is a Mock Rib with every 4th needle out of work (and counted in the stitch gauge and instructions). COLLAR: Loop Crochet. See FINISHING instructions below. The knit side of Rib is the right side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. LOOP CROCHET COLLAR: Use Yarn doubled, Make a chain 108 cm (112 cm) [116 cm] long. Work 1 row single crochet into each stitch, turn. JACKET NECKBAND: VIII Make 2.

Cast on 118 (121) [128] sts. with color 3 and work K1, P1 Ribbing with color stripes as shown on the Chart to Row 24, then bind off the crochet method for ribbing.

JACKET FRONT: I

Cast on 70 (76) [82] sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing to Row 24, then change to Stockinette stich. Knit to Row 220.

SHAPE NECK AND ARMHOLE AT THE SAME TIME. Bind off FOR ARMHOLE: 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x). [4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 3x]. Decrease 1 st. NECK EDGE every 4th row 20x, every 6th row 4x. (every 4th row 18x, every 6th row 6x). [every 4th row 13x, every 6th row 11x].

After Row 312 (316) [326], SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off 3 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 7x. (4 sts. 6x, 5 sts. 2x). [4 sts. 3x, 5 sts. 5x].

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS FOLLOWING PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

If you are following the printed instructions in KNITKING MAGAZINE, remember that the instructions are given for 3 sizes. Where shapings are the same for all sizes, you will of course follow them, but where shapings for 3 sizes follow one another, use a red pencil and circle the instructions for the size you are knitting. If at another time you wish to knit a different size, you can use another color pencil to circle that size.

REVERSE SHAPINGS FOR RAGLAN SLEEVES

The Raglan Sleeves for DK 65, DK 71, KK 83 and KK 84 in this issue, are reversed for the second sleeve. An easy way to knit this type of sleeve is to follow the instructions as given for the first sleeve then, for the second sleeve follow the instructions up to the beginning of the Raglan shaping, make your first decrease ON EACH SIDE, then turn the Row Counter to the next higher number. Now the even numbers will be on the left side and the odd numbers will be on the right side and you can follow the instructions as written for the raglan and short row shapings. The only thing you need to remember is that should you be knitting a Pattern stitch on the KNITKING machine, the Pattern stitch is always worked from right to left.

INCREASING, DECREASING, BINDING OFF, WHEN THERE ARE NEEDLES OUT OF WORK

In this issue of KNITKING MAGAZINE, there are a number of Patterns with needles in the out of work position and we remind you that the empty needles ARE COUNTED in the stitch gauge and the instructions. A MOCK RIB Pattern usually has every 4th needle out of work. When increasing or decreasing a Pattern with out of work needles, make the increases and decreases at the edge of your knitting.

Supposing you already have 3 needles in work at the edge of the knitting and you need to increase I stitch. The next increase would be an out of work needle and you cannot cast on over a needle that would be out of work. The way to make this increase is: bring a new needle into working position and cast on. Now you have 4 end needles in work. Continue with your knitting until the next increase, then with a transfer tool, pick up the end stitch and move it over to the next outside empty needle and leave it in work. Put the emptied needle into the out of work position. This will make your second increase and the first increase is now the empty needle.

If you are increasing more than 1 stitch, bring the number of needles into working position FIRST, then set the needles into Pattern. For instance, if you are increasing 3 sts. (and you already have 3 end needles in work), bring 3 new needles into working position, then put the 3rd needle (counting from the end) back into the out of work position and cast on over the 2 new needles only.

When binding off a number of stitches, you MUST make a bind off stitch over the empty needles. There are two ways you can do this. If you use

the crochet method for binding off, bring all the empty needles into working position before knitting your bind off row with a larger tension. As you crochet the stitches off, make a chain at every former empty needle space. This will prevent a too tight bind off edge.

The second way is to make the bind offs as shown in your Instruction Manual and be sure to bring the empty needles into working position so that you can make a bind off (counting it of course) over every empty needle.

If a Pattern Stitch has two or three empty needles, the increasing, decreasing and bind offs are made in the same way as above and you count each empty needle as one stitch.

TO INCREASE OR DECREASE 2 STITCHES AT THE EDGE OF YOUR KNITTING

Occasionally you will find instructions telling you to increase or decrease 2 stitches at the edge of your knitting. Usually, if there is more than a 1 stitch increase or decrease, it is called casting on - or binding off... but if we say to increase or decrease 2 sts., this is the way it is done.

1. To decrease: With a double Transfer Tool, remove the 2 end sts., then hang the sts. onto the next 2 working needles (2 stitches on each needle).

2. To increase: Move the end stitch out to the next empty needle, leave it in working position then pick up the 2nd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle. Bring an empty needle at the edge of your knitting into working position and continue knitting.

KNITTING WITH AMORE

AMORE is one of our loveliest yarns. It is a hard twist synthetic (100% Orlon) that goes into your washer and dryer and comes out soft and looking like new every time. It is a very hard wearing yarn because of its special twist. It makes up into beautiful garments... dresses, pantsuits, coats, sweaters - just about anything you want and it is perfect for children's garments because of its easy care. Some of our customers say it twists and knots when they are knitting with it... so here are some hints that absolutely will prevent this and we guarantee you too will love AMORE.

We hope you KNOW that you must ALWAYS rewind yarn when you receive it before you knit with it. Even if a ball of yarn is wound so that you can pull it from the center, you MUST rewind it yourself because it has been packaged for some time and the fibers will stick together and produce uneven knitting. Cone yarn is the only yarn that does not need to be wound into center pull balls... you can knit it right from the cone.

AMORE should be waxed... either at the time you are winding it into a pull ball, or while you are knitting with it. To wax it as you make the pull ball, use the KNITKING Waxamajig Yarn Winder. If you do not have the Waxamajig Yarn Winder, you

can use another winder and hold a piece of paraffin wax in your left hand and allow the yarn to run over the wax as you wind with your right hand. Do not hold the yarn too tight - you do not want a tight ball. If it does not pull easily from the center, you will have to rewind it without the wax.

Another way is to wax the yarn as you knit with it. Wind your center pull ball first. Some Japanese machines (Brother for instance) come equipped with a wax disc. Follow the instructions given for attaching the wax disc to your machine and the yarn will automatically be waxed as you knit. KNITKING machine owners should place the ball of yarn on the floor in back of the machine, then feed it through a hole in the back of the Yarn Container, then through the Tension Disc, the Antenna and down to the feed finger. If you do not have a hole in your Yarn Container, make one with a 1/4" drill and about half way up on the back of the Container. Now you can tape a piece of Paraffin wax with a hole in the center, right over the hole in the Yarn Container then feed the yarn through the holes in wax and container. When you knit with AMORE in this way, the yarn feeds smoothly without twisting or knotting and the knitting is beauti-fully even... try it.!! This method of waxing yarn as you knit can be used with any yarns but is especially great with any synthetics and nub yarns that might not have as much elasticity as the pure wools.

Bring the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 172 (202) [232] and complete the left half (200) [228] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



COLLAR: VIII

Cast on 115 sts. with color 1 and work 46 rows K1, P1 Ribbing, then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.





SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 15x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 18x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 20x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x]. After Row 210 (230) [248], bind off the remaining 11 (12) [11] sts.

*ON NECK SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x and SHAPE SHOULDER after Row 132 (148) [164]. Bind off 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 3x. (2 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 4x). [3 sts. 4x, 4 sts. 1x]. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 108 (124) [140] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.




