All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

 -  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.
 -  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
 -  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.
 -  Pattern Stitch
 -  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Knit side.
 -  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Purl side.
 -  Repeat
- I = Front
 - II = Back
 - III = Sleeve
 - IV = Skirt Front
 - V = Skirt Back
 - VI = Collar
 - VII = Pocket
 - VIII = Band
 - IX = Belt
 - X = Cuff
 - XI = Pants Front
 - XII = Pants Back

Finishing – Chart Symbols

-  Match numbers on section for assembling.
-  Ease
-  Fold Line
-  Turn to the wrong side and hem.

Stitch Symbols

-  Needles in holding position

-  Empty needle (leave in working position)
-  Needle not used (in the out of work position).
-  Two stitches on 1 needle, either transferred from the right side or the left side, then put into holding position.

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as [12/14] and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5×1
[6] The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5×1 above the box means - 1 st. $5 \times \dots$ so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row $5 \times$.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...
3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x].
As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping'). Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")

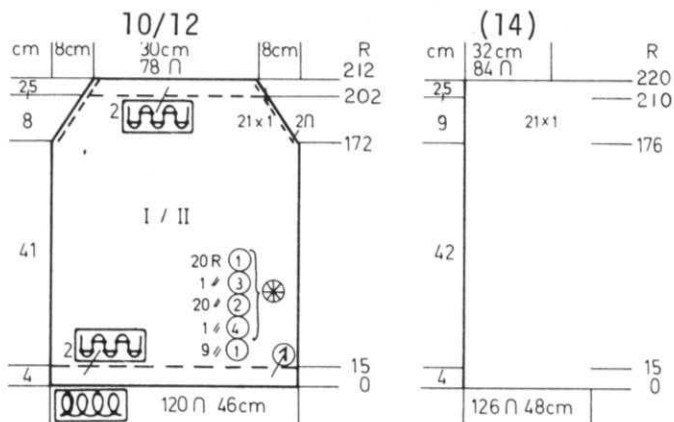
If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

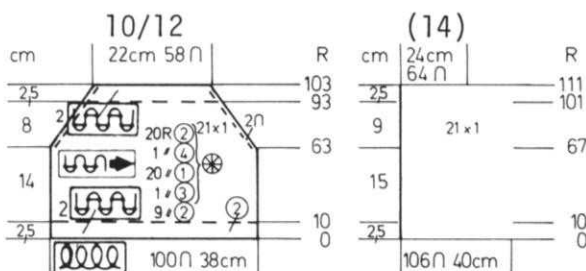
SIZES: 10/12 (14)

 color 1 50 50

 TENSION: 6 to 8
 GAUGE: 12 sts. 17 1/2 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Bands are K2, P2 Ribbing.



BACK & FRONT: 2 sections the same.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



SLEEVES: III

Cast on 100 (106) sts, with color 1 and work 10 rows ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 63 (67) SHAPE THE RAGLAN same as the front and back and after Row 93 (101), continue in Ribbing. After Row 103 (111), bind off.

Cast on 120 (126) sts. with color 1 and work 15 rows Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. After Row 172 (176), SHAPE RAGLAN using the full fashion method. Use 3 needle transfer tool and ON EACH SIDE, decrease 2 sts. then decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 21x. (Decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 21x). AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 202 (210) continue in Ribbing. After Row 212 (220), bind off.

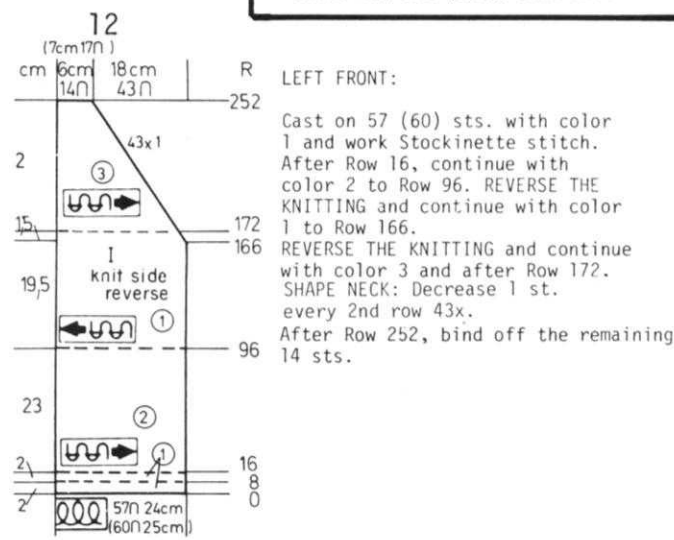

SIZES: 12
 YARN: Amore
 GRAMS:
 color 1 150
 color 2 150
 color 3 Few yards
 color 4 Few yards
 TENSION: 5 to 7
 GAUGE: 13 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Neck and Armbands are ribbed.

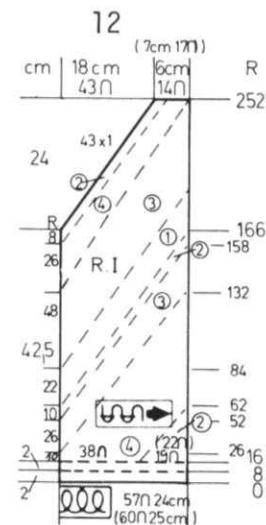
FINISHING: See General Instructions.

NOTE: The back and the left front are worked in Stripes with color changes and the knitting is REVERSED as shown. The RIGHT FRONT is worked in bias and each stripe is worked separately using SHORT ROWS.



LEFT FRONT:

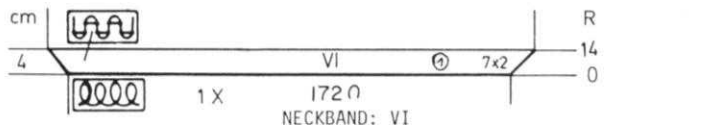
Cast on 57 (60) sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch. After Row 16, continue with color 2 to Row 96. REVERSE THE KNITTING and continue with color 1 to Row 166. REVERSE THE KNITTING and continue with color 3 and after Row 172. SHAPE NECK: Decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 43x. After Row 252, bind off the remaining 14 sts.



RIGHT FRONT: I

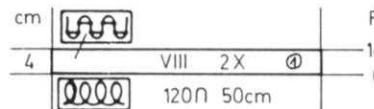
Cast on 57 (60) sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. BEGIN THE BIAS STRIPES. Put 38 sts. on the left side into holding position, then work SHORT ROWS over the 19 (22) sts. ON THE LEFT, on every 2nd row, put into holding position 1 st. to Row 52. Leave all these sts. in holding position and begin the 2nd stripe. Bring the 38 needles on the left into working position. Slide on the left, Counter at 16 and with color 4, bring 1 needle on the right back into working position and when Slide is on the right, put 1 needle on the left into holding position.

After Row 132, all the sts. will be in holding position. Begin again on the left side. Row Counter 26. and using color 3, bring 1 st. on the right into working position and 1 st. on the left into holding. Continue in this way for all the stripes, following the Chart. The last stripe is in color 2 on Row 158 and begin the neck shaping on Row 166. For neck, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 43x. The last 2 stripes end at Row 252. Bind off the last 14 sts when completing the last stripe.



NECKBAND: VI

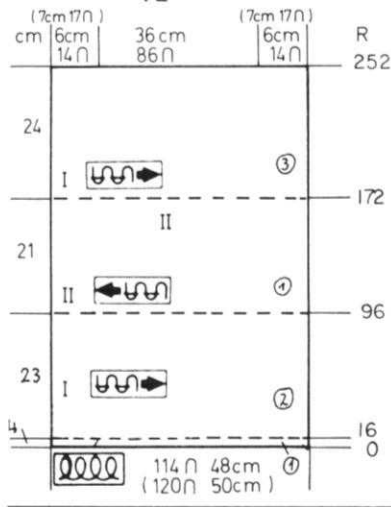
Cast on 172 sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. 7x. After Row 14, bind off.



ARMBANDS: VIII Make 2.

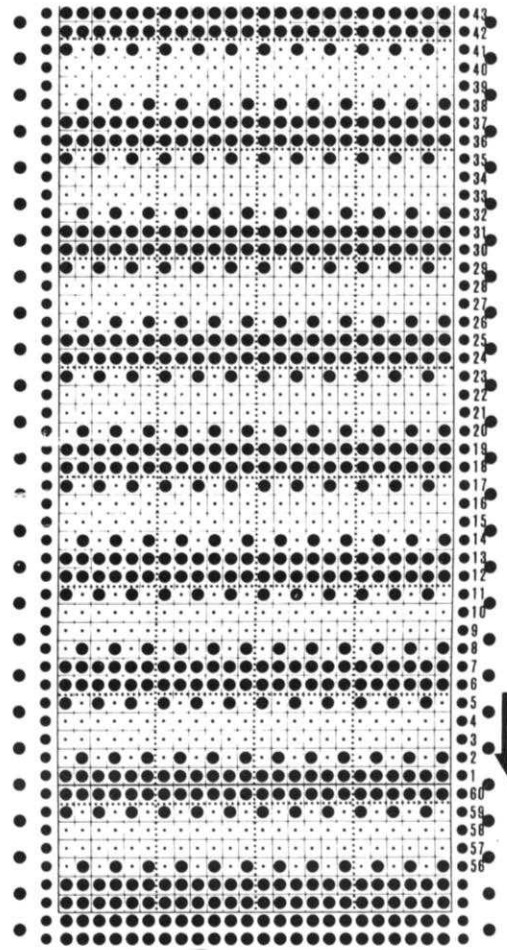
Cast on 120 sts. with color 1 and work 14 rows Ribbing. Bind off.

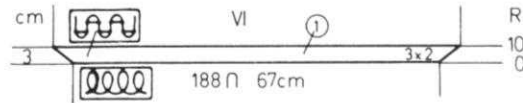
BACK: II

Cast on 114 (120) sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows Stockinette stitch. Continue with color 2.
Knit to Row 96, then REVERSE THE KNITTING. Continue with Color 1 to Row 172.
REVERSE THE KNITTING and continue with color 3.
After Row 252, bind off the 14 shoulder sts. on each side then bind off the 86 center sts. or you can remove them onto different colored waste yarn.

 Work the front the same as the back to Row 108 (116).

 *SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back and ON NECK SIDE, bind off 1 st. every 2nd row 3x (6x), then 1 st. every 4th row 19x.
 After Row 186 (194), SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
 Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 108 (116) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



BACK: II
 Cast on 144 (156 sts. with color 1 and work 20 rows Ribbing.
 Continue in Pattern with color changes as shown on the front Chart.
 After Row 108 (116) SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 2x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 3x).
 Knit to Row 186 (194).
 SHAPE SHOULDER: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 12 sts. 3x for both sizes.
 After Row 192 (200), bind off the remaining sts.



ARM BANDS: VIII Make 2.
 Cast on 140 sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 2nd row 3x.
 After Row 10, bind off or remove onto waste yarn.

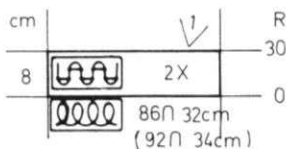

Stockinette with color stripes and knitted sideways on the machine. Waist and Neck Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Leave opening on sleeve seam for Cord. Make 2 cords 24 cm long. Pull through opening.



WAISTBANDS; Make 2.

Cast on 86 (92) sts. with color 1 and work 30 rows Ribbing. Bind off or remove onto waste yarn.

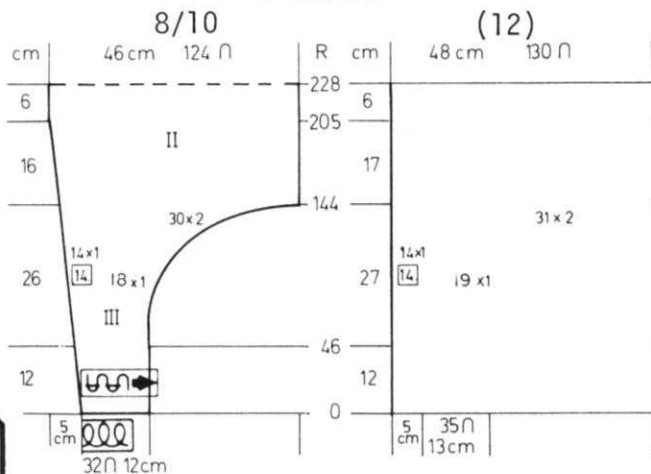

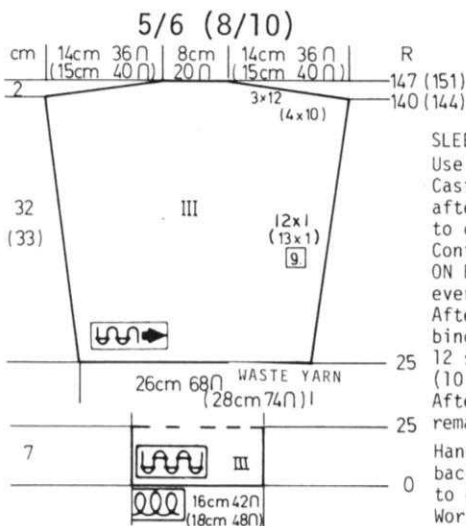
BE SURE TO READ PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS. The front is knitted in Stockinette stitch with Short Rows to form the pattern and with changes in color. The back and sleeves are Stockinette stitch. All Bands are ribbed.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



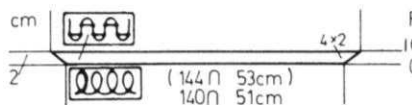
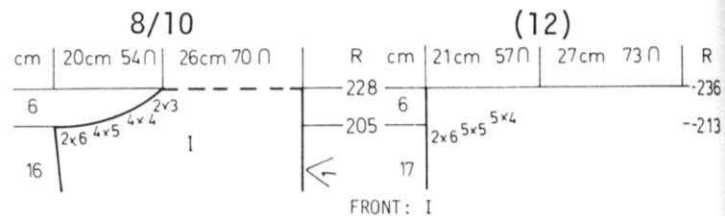
BACK: II

Cast on 110 (114) sts. with color 1 and work 22 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch. After Row 101 (109), mark each side for setting in sleeves. Knit to Row 166 (174). SHAPE SHOULDERS: ON EACH SIDE BIND OFF 13 sts. 1x, 12 sts. 2x. (13 sts. 3x). After Row 172 (182), bind off the remaining sts.



SLEEVES: III

Use open cast on with waste yarn. Cast on 68 (74) sts. and after knitting 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1 and put Counter at 26. Continue in Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE increase 1 st. every 9th row 12x (13x). After Row 140 (144), ON EACH SIDE, bind off 12 sts. 3x. (10 sts. 4x). After Row 147 (151), bind off the remaining sts. Hang the sts. held on waste yarn back onto the machine, decreasing to 42 (48) sts. Work 26 rows Ribbing with color 1. Bind off.



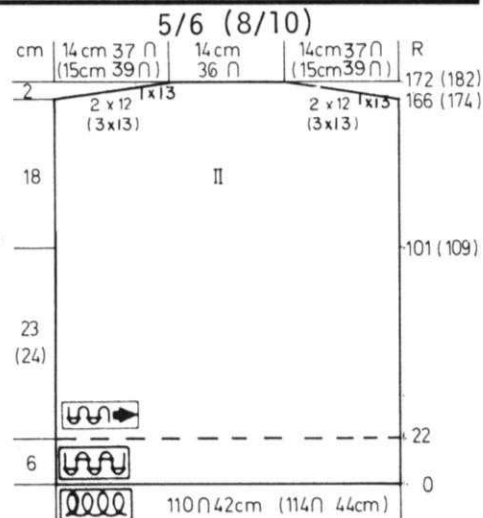
NECKBAND:

Cast on 140 (144) sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. 4x. After Row 10, remove onto waste yarn or bind off.

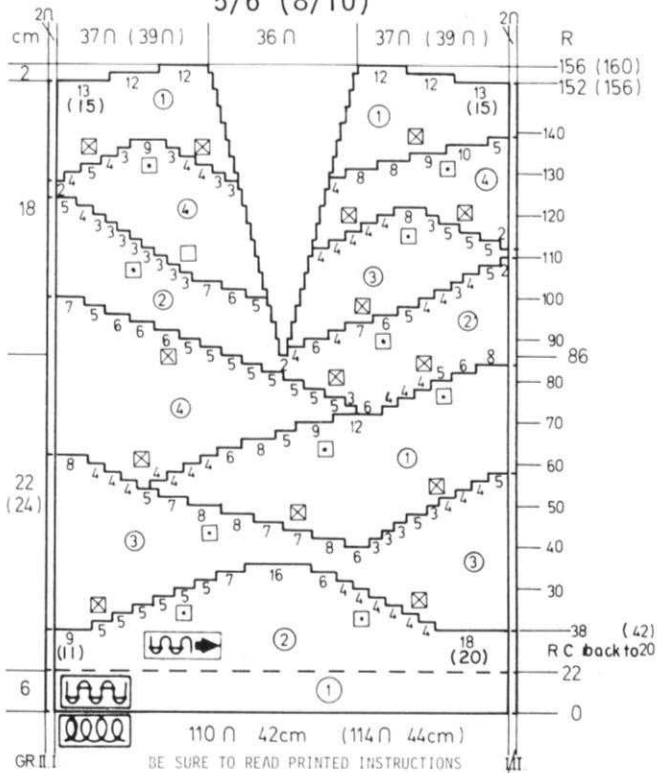
Work the front the same as the back to Row 205 (213). SHAPE NECK: Bind off 6 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 4x, 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x. (6 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 5x, 4 sts. 5x). After Row 228 (236) Mark each side for center front then WORK BACKWARDS, REVERSING THE SHAPINGS.

BACK: II

Cast on 32 (35) sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as follows:
 2 Rows color 1
 *2 Rows color 2
 8 rows color 1
 2 rows color 3
 8 rows color 1
 2 rows color 4
 8 rows color 1
 REPEAT FROM * FOR PATTERN. After Row 46, ON THE LEFT, increase 1 st. every 14th row 14x AND AT THE SAME TIME, ON THE RIGHT increase 1 st. every 2nd row 18x (19x), then cast on 2 sts. 30x (31x). After Row 205 (213), mark the left side for neck. After Row 228 (236), mark each side for center of back then REVERSE THE INSTRUCTIONS for 2nd half.



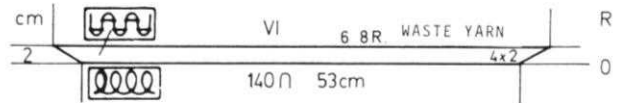

FRONT: I

Cast on 110 (114) sts. with color 1 and work 22 rows Ribbing.
Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 2.
After Row 38 (42) begin the SHORT ROWS.
ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF SLIDE, put into holding position, 9 (11) sts. Knit across, then ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF SLIDE, put into holding position 18 (20) sts. and knit across.
Now FOLLOW THE CHART, continuing the Short Rows as given. The numbers along side the chart are only a guide to help you know where you are as you are knitting the different sections. When you have completed the first Short Row Section, put the center 16 sts. into holding (the rest of the sts. on each side are already in holding) position.

TURN THE ROW COUNTER BACK TO 20 and with color 3, work the right side, bringing back the sts. as shown on the Chart. When the right section is completed, work the left section. Continue in this manner for all Short Row sections, following the Chart for the knitting and changing of colors.
After Row 86, put half the sts. into holding position and complete the right side first. Continue with the Short Rows as given.
After Row 152 (156), SHAPE SHOULDER: Bind off 13 (15) sts. 1x, 12 sts. 2x. Bring the needles on the left into working position as shown, turn the Row Counter back to 86 and complete the left half.



NECKBAND: VI

Cast on 140 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. every 2nd row 4x.
After Row 10, remove onto contrast waste yarn.

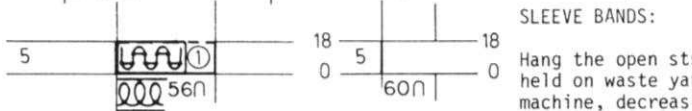
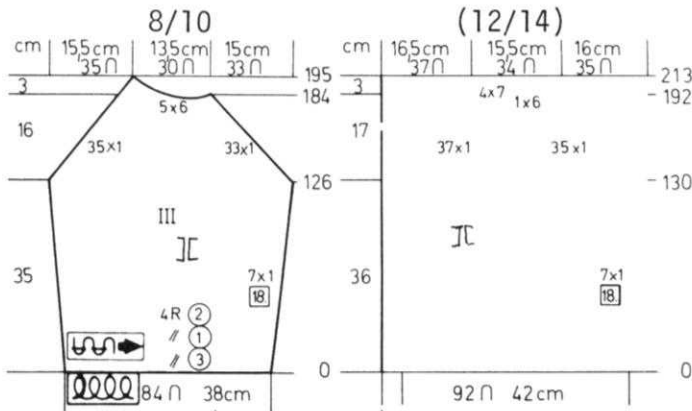
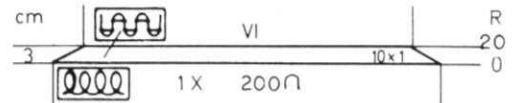
ON THE RIGHT, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 33x (35x) and

ON THE LEFT, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 35x (37x).

After Row 184 (192), bind off 6 sts. 5x.

SLEEVE BANDS:

Hang the open sts. of the sleeve held on waste yarn, back onto the machine, decreasing to 56 (60) sts. Work 18 rows Ribbing. then bind off.

Push in ONLY 1 Tuck Button. You must reverse the knitting after working the Tuck stitch so the purl side of the tuck pattern is the right side. Waistband of Pullover is K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Make twisted Monks Cords and pull through sleeves and neck of Jacket.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 5 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x (3x), 1 st. 3x, 1 st. every 10th row 6x. After Row 172 (180), bind off the center 62 (68) sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. *ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 1x for both sizes. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 172 (180) and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



JACKET SLEEVES: III

Begin at TOP of Sleeve. Cast on 110 sts. with color 2 and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes same as Jacket. After Row 180 (194), remove onto waste yarn.

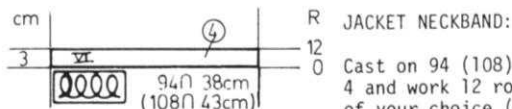


JACKET: Knitted sideways.

Cast on 140 (143) sts. with color 4 and work the band of your choice for 11 rows (See suggestions for bands in descriptive paragraph at beginning of Instructions). Continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Mark Row 39 (44) on the right side edge with a bit of contrast yarn. After Row 81 (90), bind off 55 sts. at the right then immediately cast on 55 sts. (armhole). Mark Row 123 (136) at the right edge as you did before and again after After Row 179 (198). After Row 221 (244), bind off 55 sts. at the right then immediately cast on 55 sts. (armhole). Mark Row 263 (290) on the right as you did before, then knit to Row 291 (323). Work 11 rows of seed stitch by hand or K1, P1 Ribbing - or if you used the Tuck Card, reverse the knitting and work 11 rows Tuck stitch with color 4. Bind off.

JACKET LOWER BAND:

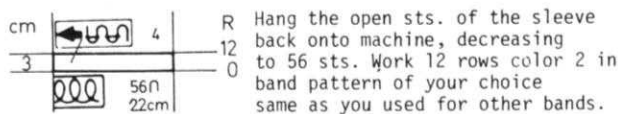
If you work seed stitch by hand you can cast on the full amount of sts. If you work the band in Tuck Stitch, you will have to make 2 pieces. Cast on 216 (240) sts. and work 12 rows color 4 in pattern of your choice same as you used for other bands.



JACKET NECKBAND:

Cast on 94 (108) sts. with color 4 and work 12 rows in pattern of your choice (same as you used for other bands). Bind off.

JACKET SLEEVE BANDS:



Hang the open sts. of the sleeve back onto machine, decreasing to 56 sts. Work 12 rows color 2 in band pattern of your choice same as you used for other bands.

KNITTING NEWS

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

CAST ON COMB HEMS

Cast on comb hems can be made at the lower edge of of garments, at the neckline and sleeve edges. We have given you instructions before on how to make these hems, but here is some updated information on making decorative hems.

The Punch Card shown here is one you can punch and use whenever you want a decorative hem. It is punched for every other needle, every 3rd needle, every 4th needle and every 6th needle. The starting row for each is marked alongside the left edge and you will set your card on the line for the needle set up you want to use.

PICOT HEM

Suppose you want a picot hem using every other needle for the picot. Make a practice piece as follows:

1. Hang the Cast on Comb. Bring 60 needles into working position.
2. Bring every other needle from working position into "D" position beginning with the 2nd needle on the left. Push in BOTH PART BUTTONS.
3. Lower tension one number from the tension you will use for garment. Knit 1 row from right to left. Release Part Buttons and lower Cast on Comb.
4. Knit 10 rows.
5. Turn Tension 2 tensions HIGHER. Knit 1 row to the right side. Turn tension back to the one you were using.
6. Insert Punch Card and set on Line 1 (2 is the number on the left side of card which means every other needle). Leave the Card on GO and move the Lace Carriage across to the right then back to the left side. You will note that every other stitch has been transferred to the left needle.
7. Knit 12 rows.
8. Bring every other needle into "D" position beginning with the 1st needle on the left.
9. Lift the Cast on Comb horizontally (put weights on back of knitting to make it easier for you) and hang the sts. from the comb onto the needles in "D" position, then remove the Cast on Comb. Bring all needles into "E" position (to keep the sts. from floating off) and make sure Carriage is set for knitting all needles. Turn Tension to garment Tension and continue knitting your garment.

If you wish to have a picot hem at the top of a Blouse or Dress, work this hem as follows: This would be for a straight boat neck hem but you can also make it for a round neckline by hanging the neck sts. back onto the machine.

When you reach the place where you want the neck band, hang the Cast on Comb, then follow the instructions above from numbers 2 through 9 and after you have hung the sts. to form the hem, bind off. You can knit 1 very loose row using tension 10 then crochet bind off by pulling one stitch through the next. If you cannot turn the tension up high enough to crochet bind off LOOSELY, then you should knit this one row by hand. Place the yarn across the open latches and knit each stitch back to position "A" then leave it there until all the stitches are held against the back of the

needle bed. Now you can latch tool bind off. You could also bind off by using any of the methods given in your Instruction Manual, as long as the finished product looks good to you and there is plenty of stretch or give to the neckline.

If the yarn is heavy, you can, after the hem is hung and the needles have been brought to "E" position, take a tapestry needle, thread it with end of yarn then simply take the stitches off in an overcast manner onto the yarn, sewing through each stitch or doubled stitch on the machine.

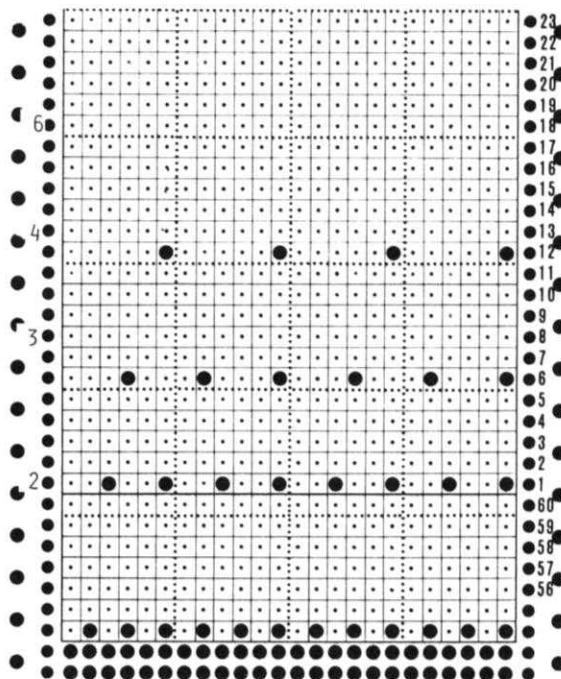
When you have completed your hem, always take a rod or ruler, push it through the hem and give a good pull downwards.

HOLDING POSITION SCALLOPED HEM

The illustrated Punch Card can be used for Holding Position Scalloped Hems as follows:

- Follow the instructions for a Picot Hem from numbers 1 through 4.
5. Insert Punch Card and set it on Line 13 (every 4th needle). Set KC, then knit 1 row from left to right. Release KC and with a ruler or the straight edge of needle selector tool, bring all of the selected needles into holding position. Set the Cam Control on the Carriage for holding needles.
 6. Hang plenty of weights on your knitting, then knit 4, 6 or 8 rows (this will depend on the yarn you are using and how deep a scallop you want).
 7. Release the Holding Cam and knit 12 rows over all needles then follow the instructions for Picot Hem from 8 through 9.

For the scalloped hem at the top of a blouse or dress, follow the instructions from 2 through 4 for the Picot Hem, then follow 5, 6 and 7 for Scalloped Hem.
