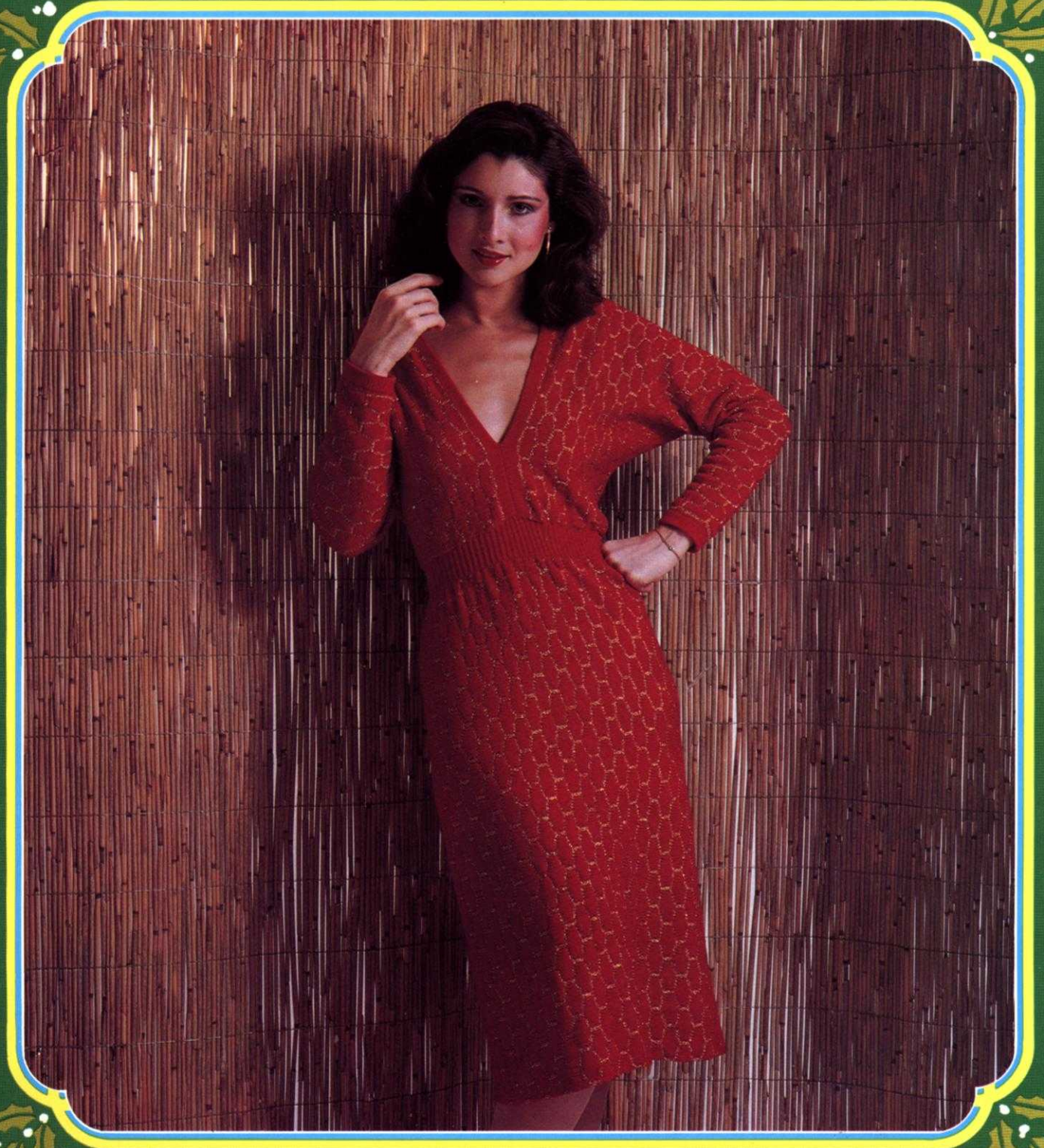

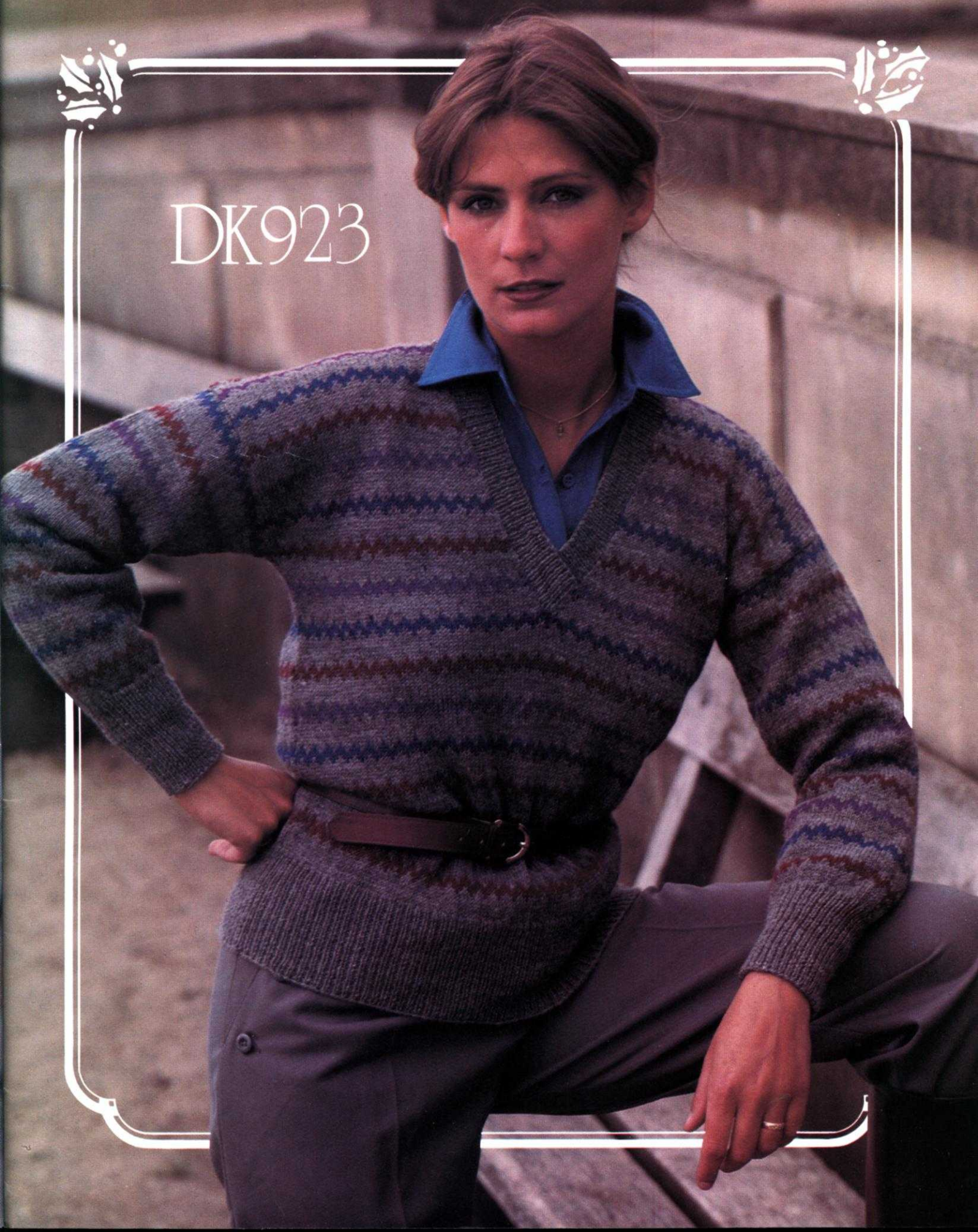

Regular readers will notice some small changes in the format of KNITKING MAGAZINE, this issue... There will be more forthcoming in future editions as we continue to improve our format.















Knitting – Chart Symbols

-  Cast on
-  Stitch
-  Row
-  Hem
-  Bind off
-  Stockinette stitch – worn on the Knit side.
-  Stockinette stitch – worn on the Purl side.

-  Number of Rows between Shapings. Make increase (or decrease) FIRST, then knit 4 rows. For example: 3 x 1  means decrease (or increase) 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows; decrease 1 st., knit 4 rows. All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

-  Increase
-  Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.





-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
-  Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.

-  Pattern Stitch
-  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Knit side.
-  Pattern Stitch – worn on the Purl side.





Finishing – Chart Symbols

General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as [12/14] and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1

6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will
Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.
Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.
Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...
3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x].
As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITTING AM 3 machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITTING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITTING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping'). Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even overnight. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

Measure the stitches with the TAPE, BETWEEN the 40 stitches marked with contrast waste yarn. Push the SLIDE so that the LEFT EDGE lines up to this exact measurement. Now look down along side the SLIDE and find the number 40 on the TAPE. The number directly opposite on the SLIDE will be your Stitch Gauge to 5 cm (2"). To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2"), place the TAPE to measure over the 60 rows, push the SLIDE to this number with the left edge lined up, the look for the number 60 on the TAPE and directly opposite this will be the number of rows to 5 cm (2")

If you do not own a KNITTING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

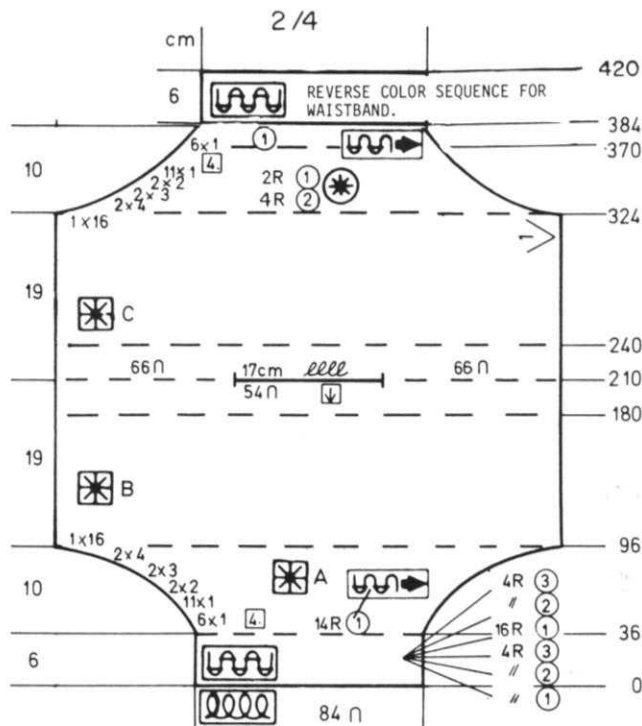
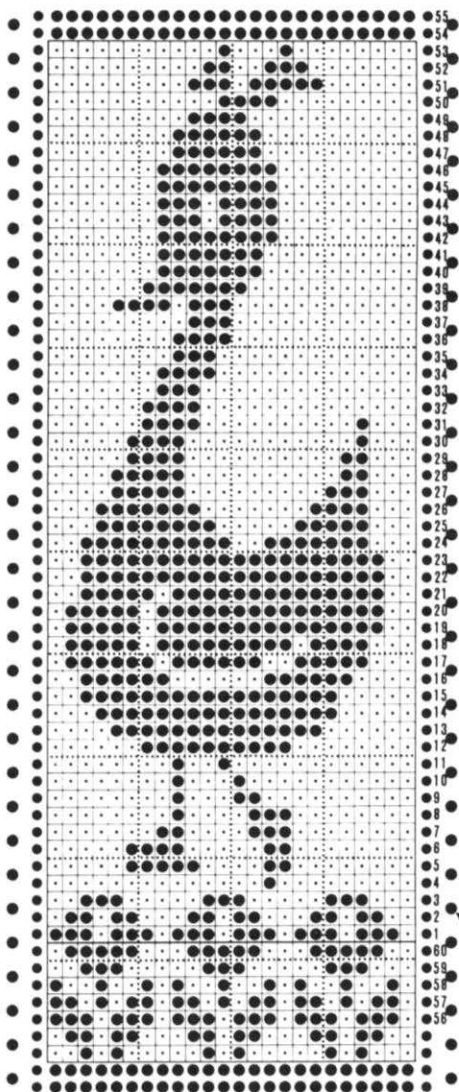

SIZE 2 to 4
 YARN: Amore
 GRAMS: color 1 100
 colors 2, 3, 4, 5, 6 -50 gr. each color.
 TENSION: 4 to 6
 GAUGE: 16 sts. 30 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Norwegian Design and color stripes as shown on the Charts.
 Bands are striped with K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



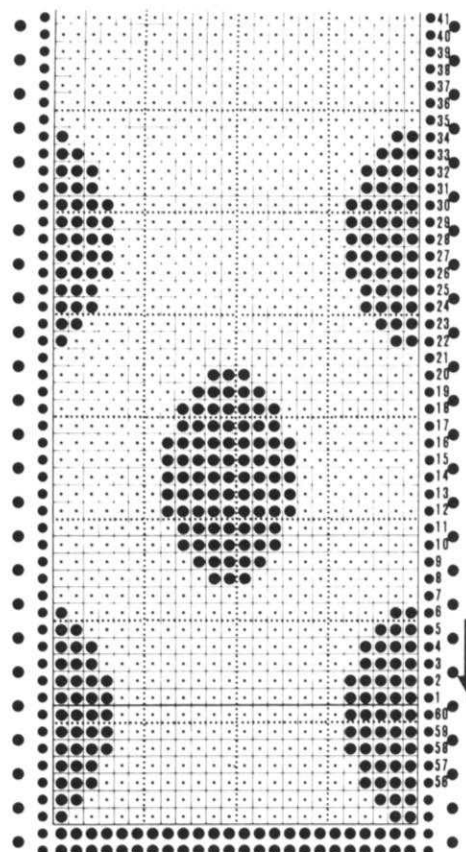

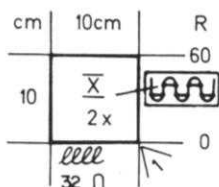
PATTERN A = FLOWERS

Knitted in one piece. Begin at lower edge. Cast on 84 sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows Ribbing with color stripes as shown on the Chart.
 Transfer the Ribber sts. and work 14 rows color 1 in Stockinette st., then continue in PATTERN A (Flowers) AND AT THE SAME TIME, ON EACH SIDE, ON EVERY 4th ROW, increase 1 st. 6x then on every 2nd row, increase 1 st. 11x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 2x, 16 sts. 1x and after Row 96, continue in PATTERN B (Duck). After Row 180, continue in Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart.
 After Row 210, bind off the center 54 sts. then IMMEDIATELY CAST on over these same needles. Continue in the Color stripes to Row 240 then work PATTERN C (Dots). After Row 324, work the color stripes as shown on the Chart AND AT THE SAME TIME, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 16 sts. 1x, 4 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 11x, then ON EVERY 4th row decrease 1 st. 6x. After Row 370, work Stockinette stitch with color 1 to row 384. Transfer the sts. to Ribber and work 16 rows Ribbing with color stripes in REVERSE. After Row 420, bind off.



CUFFS:

Cast on 32 sts. (or you can hang the sleeve onto machine, decreasing to 32 sts. Work 12 rows each of 5 different colors in K1, P1 Ribbing. (See Picture). Bind off.

WOMAN'S COAT

SIZES: 8/10

YARN: Knitting worsted weight + Novelty yarn + thin yarn for attaching Yoke to lower section.

GRAMS: color 1 1100 (Knitting worsted weight)
color 2 100 (Novelty yarn)

color 3 50 (thin strong yarn)

TENSION: 6 to 8

GAUGE: 8 sts. 10 rows = 5 cm (2")

MADE ON THE JUMBO MACHINE.

Stockinette stitch with eyelets (for pulling color 2 through holes).

FINISHING: Put the Skirt sections together. Hang the back from the center to end - then front onto machine.

With color 2, knit 1 row, then work eyelet row, knit 1 row then hang the yoke to these stitches and bind off. REPEAT for other side.

Pull the heavy novelty yarn through the eyelets (see picture). Work 2 rows single crochet around neck and front edges.

FRONT & BACK:

Make 4 sections the same - two for back and 2 sections for fronts.

Cast on 95 sts. with color 1 and knit 2 rows. *Color 2, knit 1 row. Transfer every 2nd st. to next needle and leave empty needles in working position (eyelet row). Knit 1 row. With color 1, knit 12 rows, then REPEAT from * 3x more. (4x in all). After Row 46, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 30th row 5x. After Row 170, remove onto waste yarn.

YOKE & SLEEVES:

Begin at sleeve edge. Cast on 48 sts. and work in Pattern same as the Front and Back BUT WORK ONLY 10 ROWS BETWEEN THE EYELETS. Continue in Stockinette stitch with color 1. After Row 100, ON EACH SIDE, cast on 19 sts. After Row 118, work the EYELET PATTERN same as fronts and back with ONLY 10 ROWS BETWEEN THE EYELETS.

After Row 147, ON THE LEFT, bind off (or remove onto waste yarn) 46 sts.

Continue in Pattern to Row 167 then cast on 46 sts.

Knit in Pattern to Row 188.

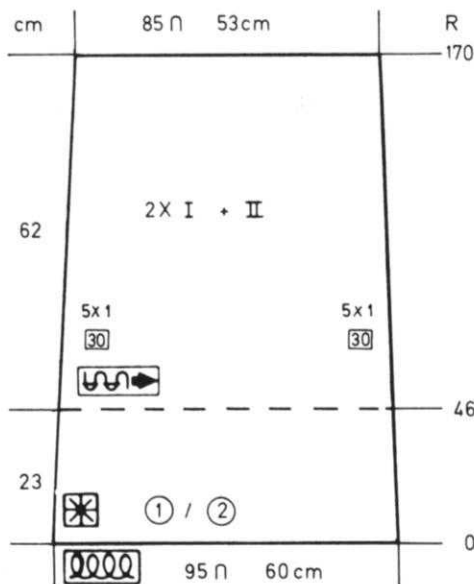
Continue in Stockinette stitch to Row 206.

ON EACH SIDE, bind off 19 sts. Knit to Row 278.

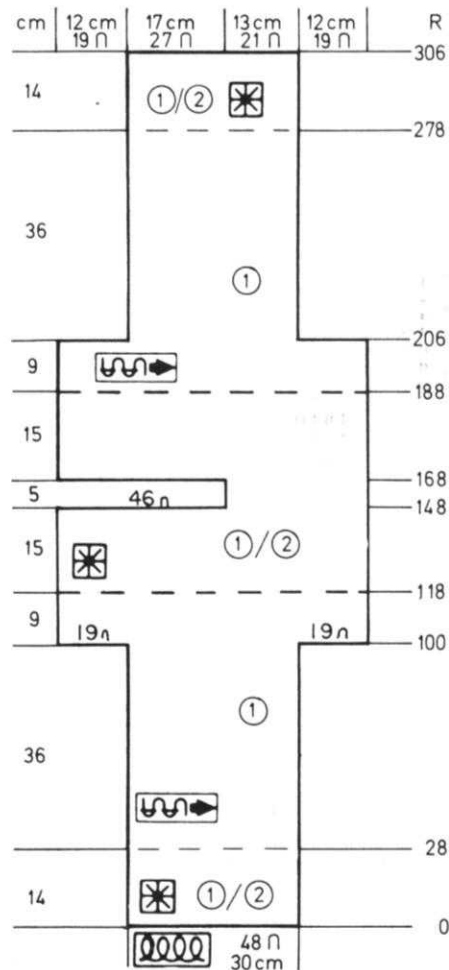
Work the Pattern same as for other sleeve.

After Row 306, bind off.

WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14)

YARN: Alpacryl

GRAMS: color 1 150 150
color 2 50 50
color 3 200 200

TENSION: 8 or 9

GAUGE: 11 1/2 sts. 28 rows = 5 cm (2") in Pattern.

A slip stitch pattern for the body and sleeves of Pullover. Punch your own Card and push in BOTH PART BUTTONS. The purl side of pattern is the right side and garment MUST BE REVERSED before knitting the Picot Trims (see picture and watch instructions). Bands for waist and sleeves are K2, P2, Ribbing.

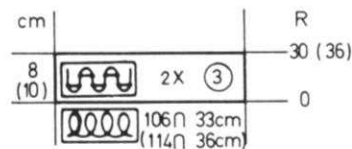
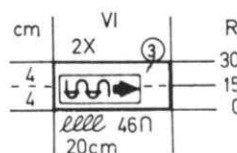
FINISHING: See General Instructions.

WAISTBAND: Make 2.

Cast on 106 (114) sts. with color 3 and work 30 (36) rows Ribbing. Transfer the ribber sts. to main machine, then hang the waist onto these same needles and bind off. REPEAT for other half.

NECKBAND: Make 2.

Cast on 46 sts. with color 3 and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 15 rows, 1 row with tension 10 then knit 15 rows. Hang hem and bind off.



DK 912

BEGIN AT SLEEVE EDGE.

Cast on 50 (55) sts. with color 1 and work 30 rows Ribbing.

Transfer the Ribber sts. to main machine and with color 1 continue in the slip stitch pattern.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st.

every 30th row 6x.

After Row 230 ON EACH SIDE, ON EVERY 4th ROW, cast on

1 st. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 1x.

After Row 252, ON EACH SIDE, cast on ALL STS. (200 needles in work).

Knit to Row 258.

REVERSE KNITTING.

Knit 1 row Tension 10.

After Row 266, transfer every 2nd st. to neighboring needle and leave empty needles in working position.

Knit to Row 276 then hang the hem (pick up the tension 10 row).

Change to color 2. Knit to Row 286.

Knit 1 row Tension 10.

After Row 294, Make picot row same as before and after Row 304, hang the hem as before.

Change to color 3 and knit to Row 314. Knit 1 row Tension 10 then

knit to Row 322. Make Picot Row as before and after Row 332, hang the hem as before. REVERSE KNITTING.

Work in Pattern to Row 354 (360)

Bind off the center 18 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and work the right side first.

Continue in Pattern to Row 466 (472)

Put these needles into holding position and bring the needles on the left into working position to work the left side.

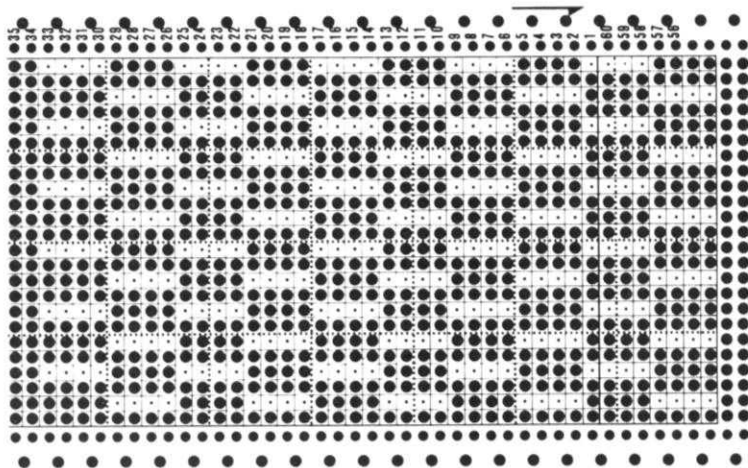
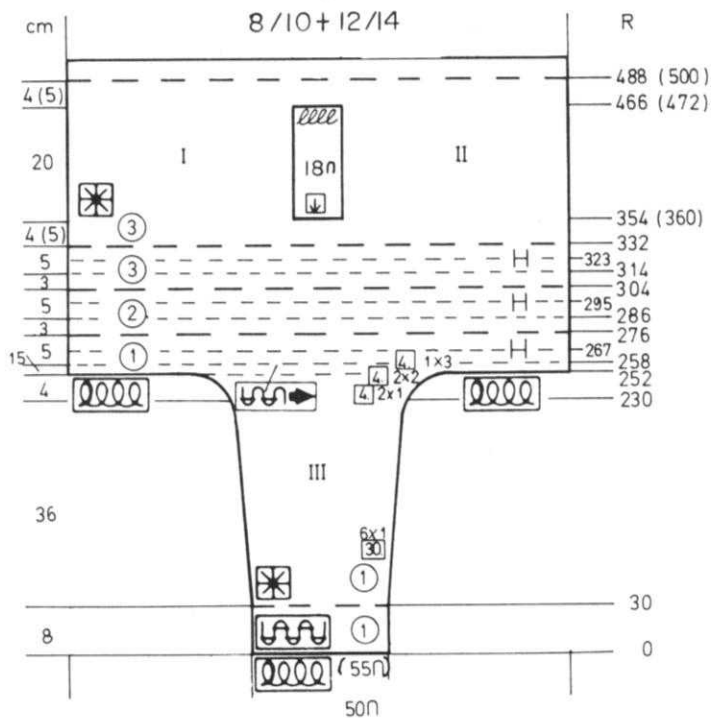
Counter at 354 (360).

Knit in Pattern to Row 466 (472).

Cast on the center 18 sts., bring all the needles into working position and put Counter at 466 (472).

Knit in Pattern to Row 488 (500) then remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

Work the 2nd section with reverse shaping up to Row 332. Leave the sts. on the needles and hang the first section onto these same needles then bind off.



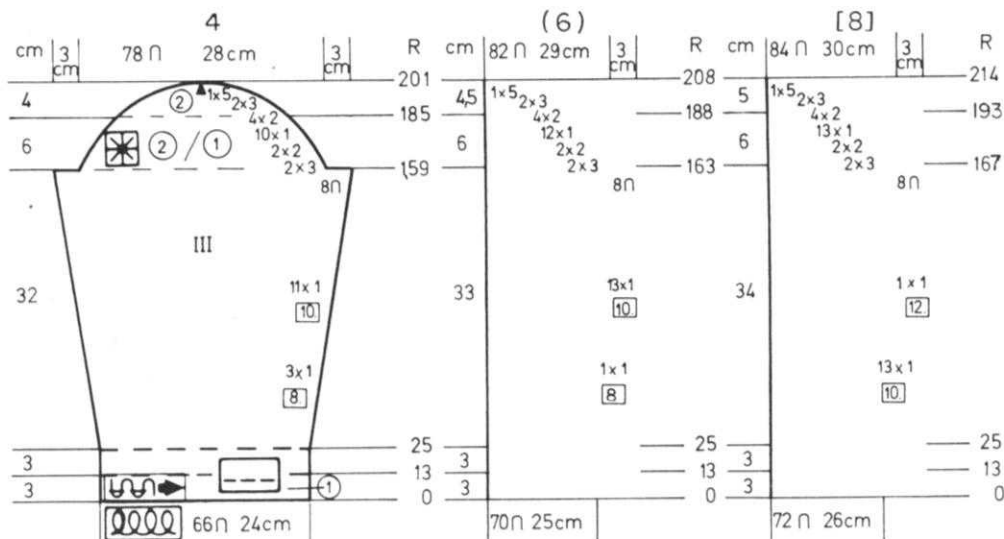

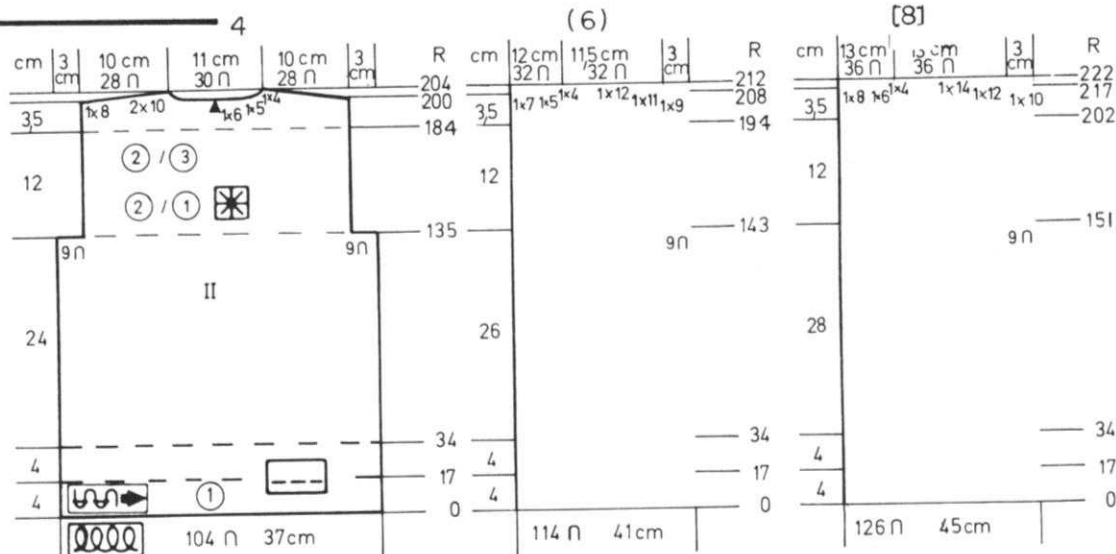
CHILD'S 2-PIECE SUIT

SIZES: 4 (6) [8]
 YARN: Mohair
 color 1 400 400 450
 color 2 50 50 50
 color 3 50 50 50
 TENSION: 6 or 7
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 21 rows = 5 cm (2")

Use the Ribber with 830 Color Changer for the design on top of Jacket. Punch your own Card.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.





JACKET BACK: II

Cast on 104 (114) [126] sts. with color 1 and work with 1 strand of yarn to Row 17. Knit 1 row Tension 9 or 10 then continue with double yarn.

After Row 34, hang the hem. Knit to Row 135 (143) [151]. ON EACH SIDE, bind off 9 sts. Set the Pattern on the next row from left to right and continue in Pattern as shown on the Chart, using 1 strand color 1 & 2 then 2 & 3 till Pattern is completed at Row 184 (194) [202]. Continue with 1 strand color 2 to Row 200 (208) [218].

SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

Bind off the center 12 (14) [16] sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first.

*FOR SHOULDER, bind off 8 sts. 1x, 10 sts. 2x (9 sts. 1x, 11 sts. 1x, 12 sts. 1x) [10 sts. 1x, 12 sts. 1x, 14 sts. 1x] FOR NECK, bind off for all sizes 5 (5) [6] sts. 1x, 4 sts. 1x. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 200 (208) [218] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 66 (70) [72] sts. with single strand of color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.

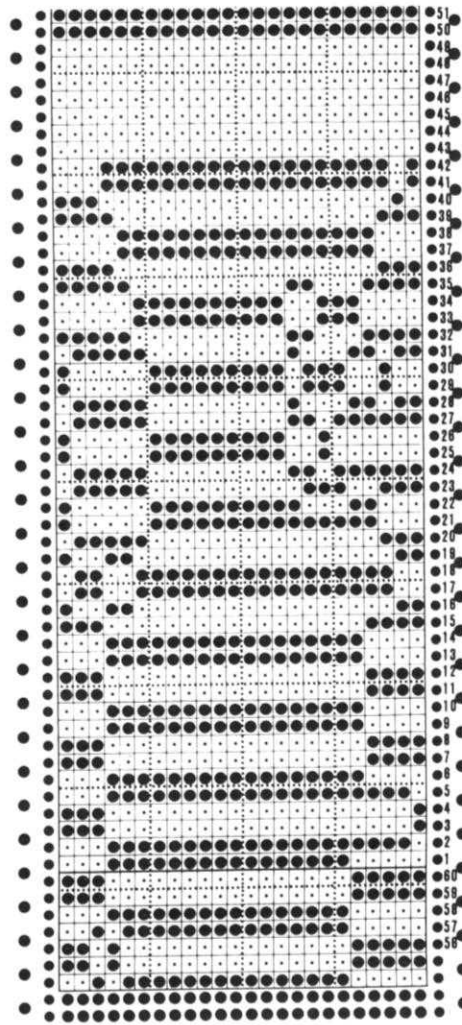
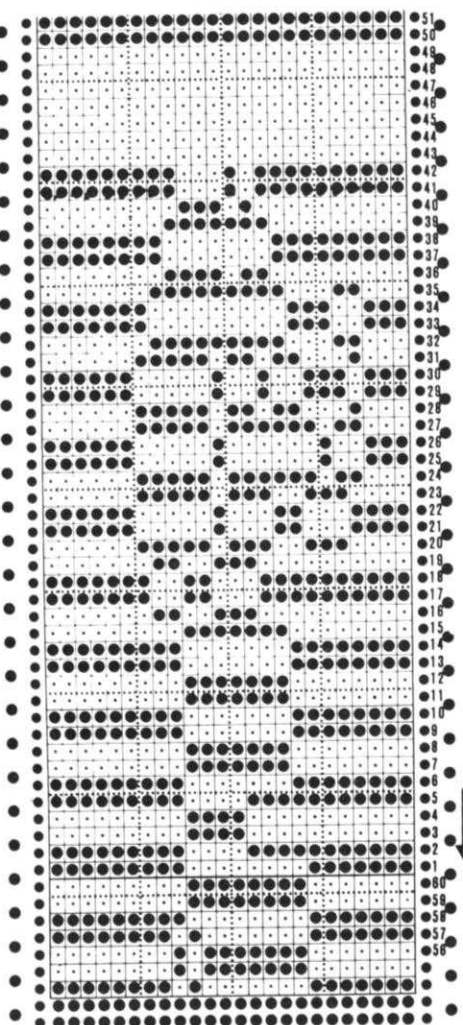
After Row 13, continue with double yarn.

After Row 25, hang the hem. ON EACH SIDE, increase

1 st. every 8th row 3x, every 10th row 11x. (every 8th row 1x, every 10th row 13x).

[every 10th row 13x, every 12th row 1x].

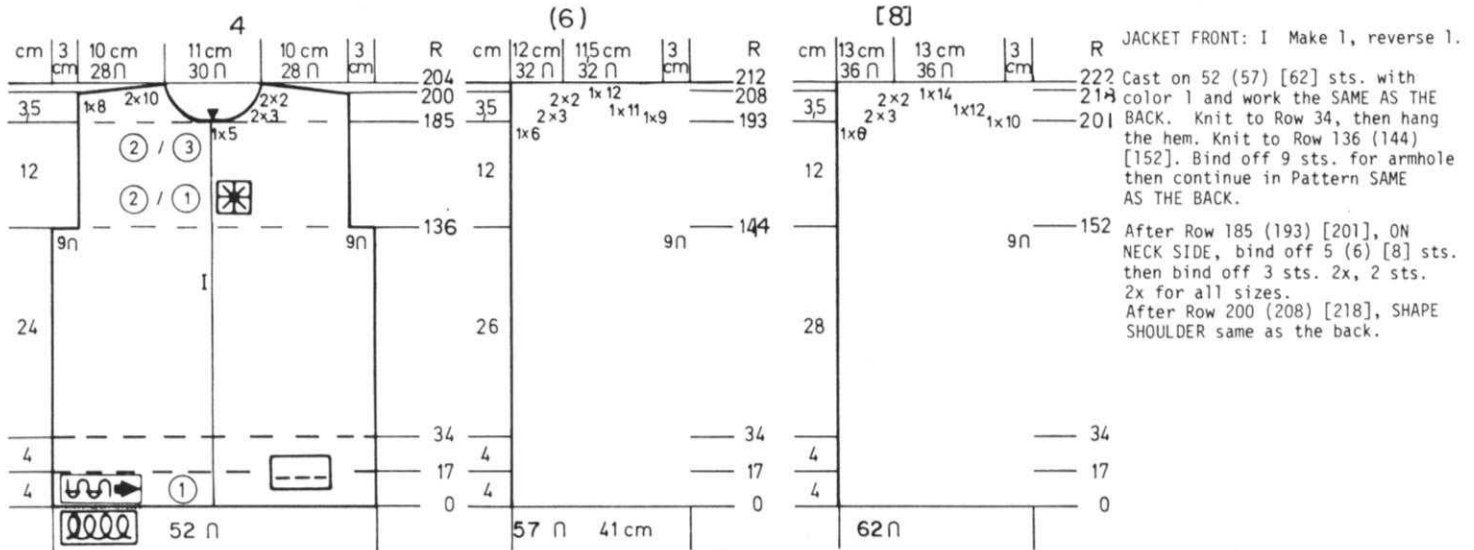
After Row 159 (163) [167] Begin Pattern with color 2 and 1 and ON EACH SIDE, bind off 8 sts.



SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 10x, 2 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 2x 5 sts. 1x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 12x, 2 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 2x, 5 sts. 1x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 13x, 2 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x] BUT AT THE SAME TIME, change to Stockinette stitch with color 2 after Row 185 (188) [193].

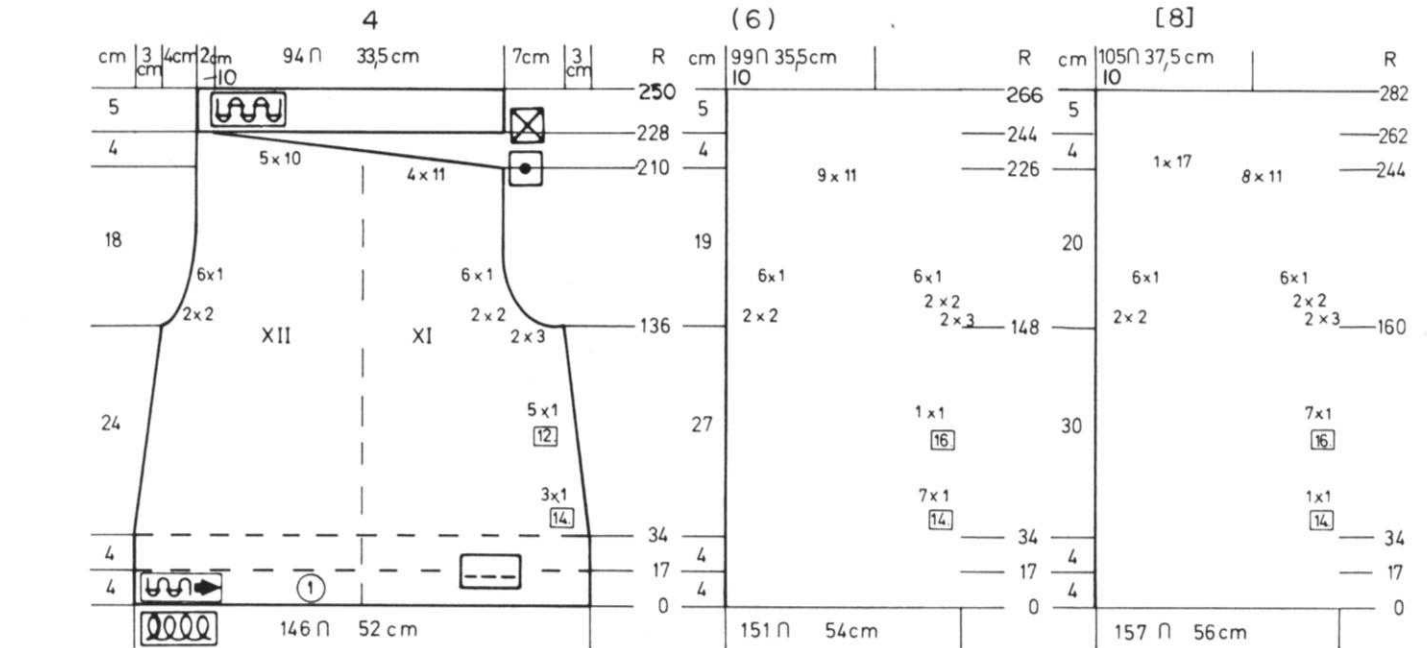
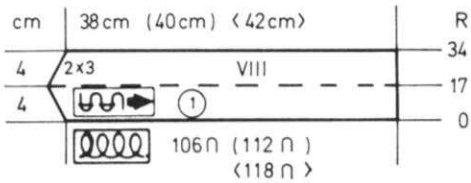
When working the Pattern, leave the KC on at all times. The plain rows are knitted with the main color and you must RELEASE the PART BUTTONS. When the needles set into pattern, push both PART BUTTONS IN. Remember that the second set of elephants are knitted in another color.





FRONT BANDS:

Hang right front edge of Jacket onto machine on 106 (112) [118] needles. With 1 strand color 1, knit 16 rows Stockinette stitch BUT AT THE SAME TIME, at left edge increase 1 st. every 4th row 3x. After Row 17, use 2 strands of yarn and tension 10 and increase 1 st. every 4th row 3x. Remove onto waste yarn. Work the left front band with reverse shapings.
 (IF YOU WANT BUTTONHOLES ON THE RIGHT FRONT BAND, work them in and space them as desired).



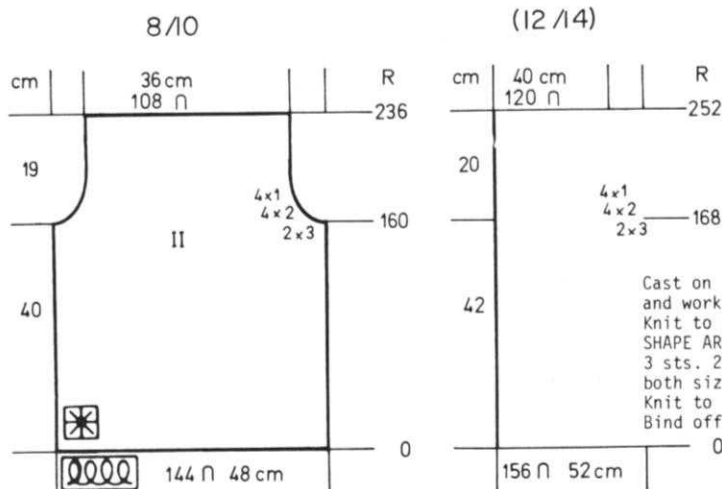

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14)
 YARN: Pingouin Pescadou
 GRAMS: color 1 700 750
 color 2 400 450
 color 3 250 300
 TENSION: 8 to 9 - Jacket
 7 to 8 - Pullover & Skirt
 GAUGE: 13 sts. 25 rows = Pull. & Skirt
 15 sts. 20 rows = Jacket = 5cm

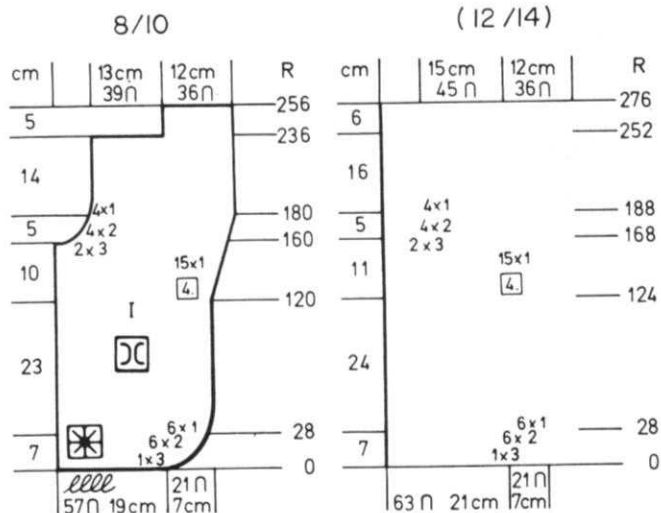
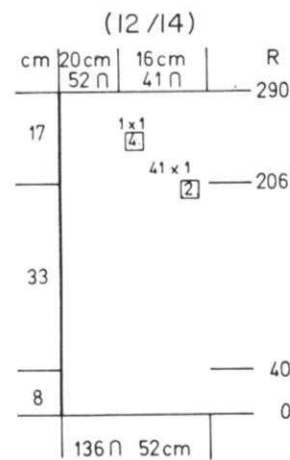
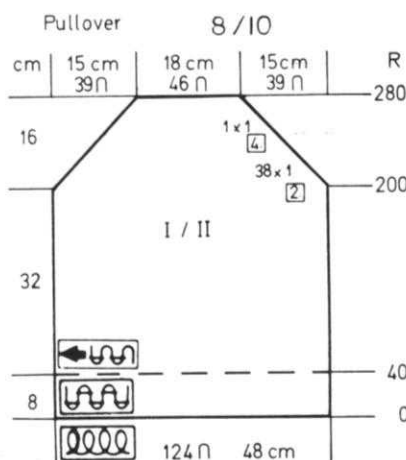
The Jacket is knitted in Norwegian technique. 840 Machine owners use Card No. 1 - or punch your own Card. The purl side is the right side. The Pullover is striped in color 1 & 2. The skirt is Stockinette stitch using color 1.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Work Double Crochet using 2 strands of yarn around all edges of Jacket.



JACKET BACK: II

After Row 76, SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 2x. Knit to Row 124. Bind off the center 10 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right side first. ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x.



After Row 130, bind off the remaining sts. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 124 and complete the left half. ON NECK SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x. After Row 129, ON NECK SIDE, increase 1 st. 7x, 2 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x, 6 sts. 1x. After Row 152, bind off 7 sts. 5x, 8 sts. 1x.

FRONT: II

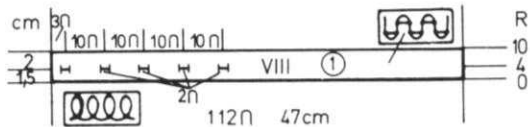
Work the front the same as the back to Row 76. SHAPE ARMHOLE ON EACH SIDE, same as the back, and after Row 96, bind off 8 sts. 1x, 7 sts. 5x, and after Row 108, bind off 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 7x. After Row 130, bind off the remaining sts.

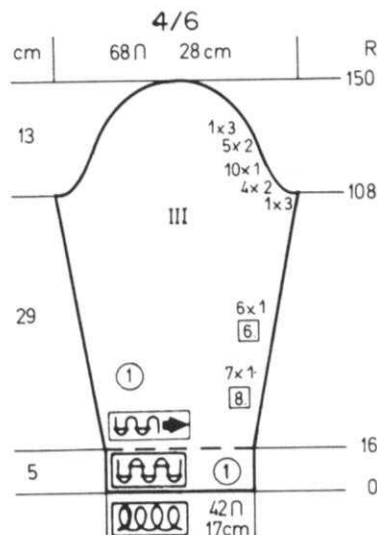
NECKBAND: VIII

Cast on 112 sts. with color 2 and work in Ribbing. After Row 4, counting from the LEFT, make the first BUTTONHOLE over needles 4 and 5. Make the following buttonholes over 2 needles with 10 sts. between each one. A total of 5 buttonholes. After Row 10, bind off or remove onto contrast waste yarn.



SLEEVES: III

Cast on 42 sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows Ribbing. Continue in Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 7x, every 6th row 6x. After Row 108, SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 10x, 2 sts. 5x, 3 sts. 1x.

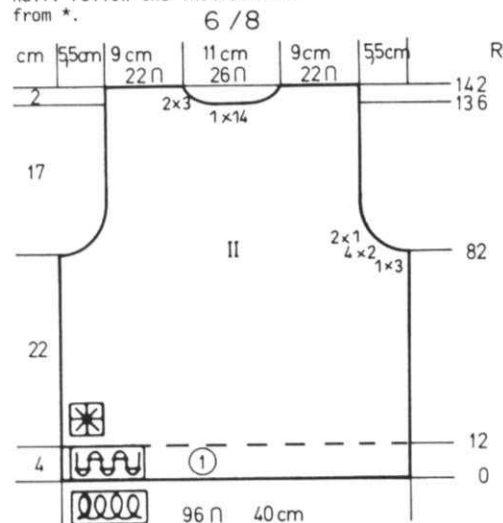

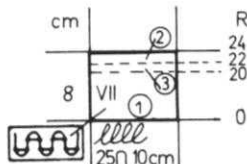

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 136 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



POCKET: Make 2.

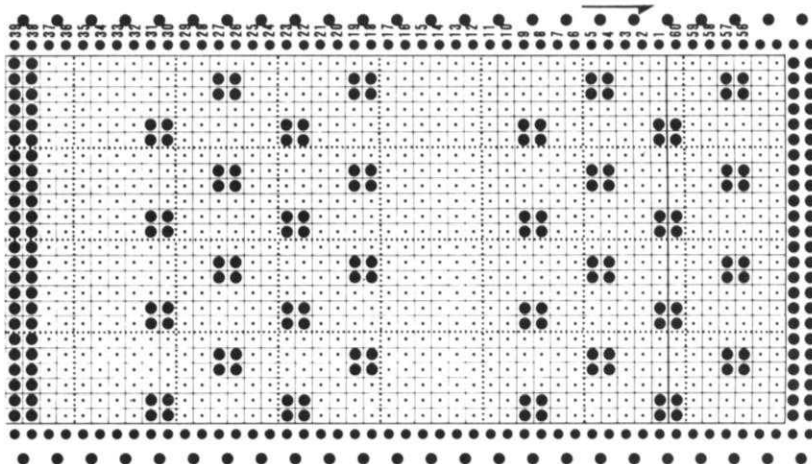

Remove the 25 sts onto a stitch holder then hang the open pocket sts. with right side facing you onto the empty needles and hang the sts. from the stitch holder onto the same needles. Continue in Pattern. After Row 82, SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back, then knit to Row 119. SHAPE NECK: Bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 2x. After Row 142, bind off the remaining sts.





FRONT BANDS: Make 1 with and 1 without BUTTONHOLES.

Cast on 92 sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing.
After Row 4, make BUTTONHOLES. Leave 6 sts. on the left and work buttonhole over the next 2 sts. Leave 16 sts. between and work buttonhole over the following 2 sts. etc. etc. for a total of 5 buttonholes. After Row 8, bind off or remove onto waste yarn.

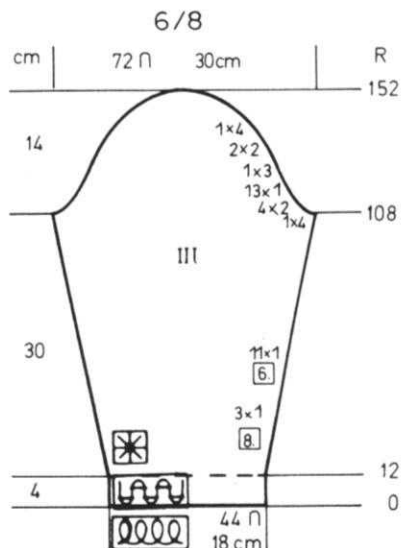


NECKBAND: VI

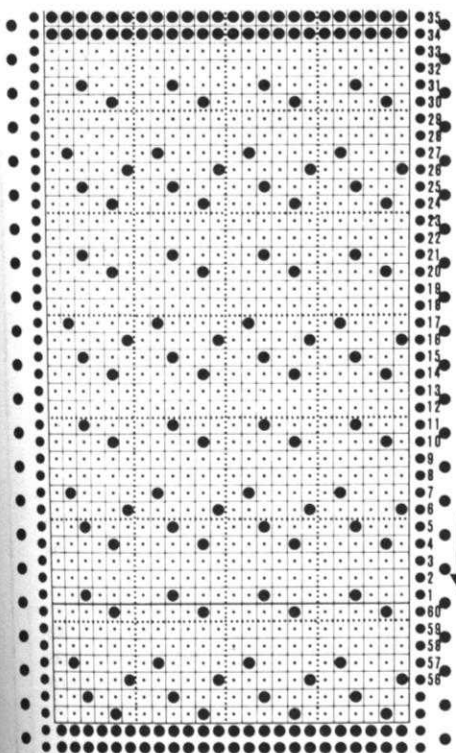
Cast on 68 sts. with color 1 and work in Ribbing.
After Row 4, on the left, leave 2 sts. and make one buttonhole over the next 2 sts.
After Row 8, bind off or remove onto contrast waste yarn.

SLEEVES: III

Cast on 44 sts. with color 1 and work 12 rows Ribbing.
Continue in Pattern.
ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 3x, every 6th row 1x.
After Row 108, SHAPE CAP:
ON EACH SIDE, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 13x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 1x.



Lace Collar & Cuffs



YARN: Vienna
GRAMS: 50
TENSION: 5 or 6
GAUGE: 15 sts. 23 rows = 5 cm
measured over pattern st.

A Lace Pattern with changes in Tensions and Stockinette stitch.
Punch Card.
FINISHING: Press carefully then remove the waste yarn. Hide ends. Fold on the large tension row and press. Sew to dress or blouse with folded edge to inside, or you can sew small button on the left edge, make crochet loop for buttonhole. Tack on the underside to dress or blouse.

BEGIN ALL SECTIONS WITH CONTRAST WASTE YARN AND RAVEL CORD.
WORK "e" (permanent) cast on over the Ravel Cord.

COLLAR: Make 2 sections.

Bring needle 48 on the left and needle 45 on the right into working position., then all needles in between. 93 sts. Cast on over the 93 sts. with waste yarn. After knitting 9 to 11 rows, work 1 row Ravel Cord, then 'e' cast on. Knit 2 rows and begin lace Pattern with Tension 5.

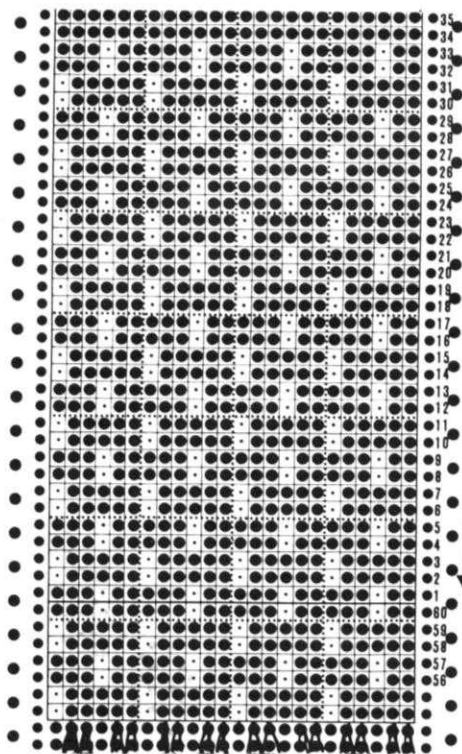


Knit to Row 10.
Change Tension to 4.2, knit to Row 18.
Change to Tension 3 and Stockinette stitch.
Knit to Row 28.
Knit 1 row Tension 6 or 7. Turn Tension back to 3 and knit to Row 38. Bind off the crochet method - loosely.

CUFFS: Make 2.

Use the same method for casting on as you did for the Collar.
Cast on 66 sts. and with tension 4, knit in Pattern same as Collar to Row 14.
Change to Stockinette stitch and tension 3. Knit to Row 20.
Work 1 row Tension 6 or 7.
Change tension back to 3 and knit to Row 30. Bind off the crochet method - loosely.

Slippers



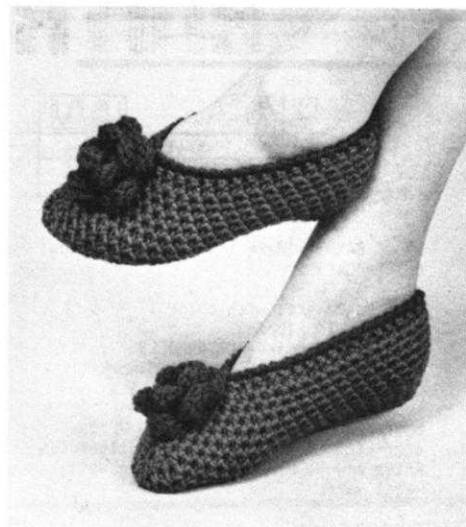
SIZES: Small Medium Large
 YARN: Euro Sport
 GRAMS: 100 100 100
 TENSION: 9 or 10 over EVERY 3rd NEEDLE
 GAUGE: 8 sts. 22 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Tuck Stitch Pattern using every 3rd needle. Punch your own Card and push in BOTH TUCK Buttons. Worn on purl side.

FINISHING: Sew up front to end of decreases. Pull up the cast on edge firmly then sew up back seam (Remove waste yarn first). Work 1 row single crochet around top edge, going into every other stitch on edge, then work 1 row reverse single crochet. Trim front with pom-poms or flowers. You can use contrast color for the crochet and trim if you wish.

NOTE: WAX YARN for easier knitting in Pattern. Use plenty of weights so the doubled stitches will knit off.

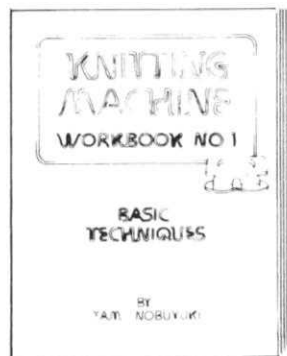
Cast on 25 (27) [27] sts. in the following way. Bring the first needle to the right of 0 into working position then bring every 3rd needle into work on each side. You will end with needle 36 on the left, 38 on the right for small size - needle 39 on the left and needle 40 on the right for medium and large sizes.



Cast on with contrast waste yarn and after knitting 8 to 10 rows 'e' cast on over the waste yarn (closed cast on). Hang plenty of weights. Counter at 0. Knit 1 row to the left side, Set Card on Stop, push in KC and knit 1 row to the right side. Push in BOTH TUCK BUTTONS and knit in Pattern to Row 70 (78) [88]. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row until 11 (13) [13] stitches remain. Knit 1 row over all needles then remove the sts. onto end of yarn. Pull up and tie tightly.

KNITTING NEWS

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

ADD A STITCH FOR SEAMING

When you need to work a front or back of a garment in sections (for a specific Design such as in DK 915 in this issue), it will be easier for you to put the parts together if you will add 1 stitch for seaming when you knit each section.

DK 915 in this issue is an example where you need to add the extra stitches as follows:
After Row 190 (200), put all but 23 sts. on the right into holding position. You need an extra stitch on the left of the 23 sts. in working position - so, remove 2 or 3 of the holding stitches directly next to the 23 sts. in work and put them on a pin or strand of yarn (to be picked up later) Although you only need 1 empty needle to add the extra stitch, it makes knitting easier for you when you remove the 2 or 3 sts. Add the extra stitch and you now have 24 sts. Continue knitting this section and follow the instructions as given. When you have completed the armhole shaping, knit to row 506 (520) then bind off.

Put the Row Counter to 190, bring all the needles into working position and hang the 2 or 3 sts. held on the pin back onto the machine, then add 1 extra stitch for seaming. Knit to Row 290 (300) then put 23 sts. on the left into holding position Remove 2 or 3 sts. onto a pin from the holding needles on the right, add 1 extra stitch for seaming to the left side of the 42 needles in work and continue to knit this section.

When you have completed this section, bring the remaining needles into working position, hang the 2 or 3 sts. held on pin back onto the machine, add 1 extra stitch and complete this section as given in the instructions.

When you are ready to put your garment together, you will find that seaming 1 stitch in on all parts will give you the perfect professional finish.

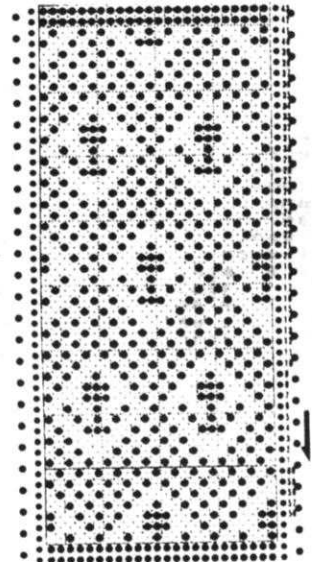
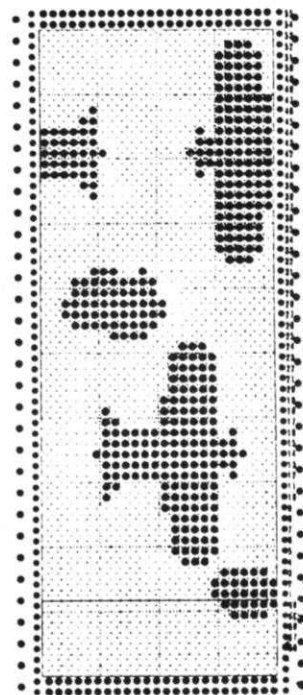
