
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
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
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FAIR ISLE V SWEATER WITH COLLAR

SIZE:

To fit 81-106 cms/32-42 inch bust.

MATERIALS:

Double Knitting.

400(450,500,550,600,650) grms in col 1 (grey)

90(100,110,120,130,140) grms in col 2 (yellow)

40(50,60,70,80,90) grms in col 3 (red) 40(50,60,70,80,90) grms in col 4

(turquoise)

90(100,110,120,130,140) grms in col 5 (black)

7 buttons - special card (page 78 - HK160 Pattern Collection)

TENSIONS:

25 sts and 36 rows to 10 cms measured over stockinet. Tension Dial at approximately 8. 26 sts and 32 rows to 10 cms measured over Fair Isle. Tension Dial at approximately 8.

ABBREVIATIONS:

See page 1.

NOTES:

Figures in brackets refer to the larger sizes respectively. All increasings should be worked by using a single transfer tool and moving the end st 1 N out, then pick up loop below adjacent st and place onto empty N. All decreasings should be worked by using a double transfer tool and moving the 2 end sts 1 N in.

Fair Isle Pattern

With col 5 in feeder 1 and col 2 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows


With col 5 in feeder 1 and col 3 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows.

With col 5 in feeder 1 and col 4 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows.

Rept throughout.

BACK FAIR ISLE PANEL

Insert special card into machine and lock on row 1. Push 1 N at left and right of centre 0 to B pos (2 Ns altog). Using col 5 cast on by hand. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8, knit 2 rows. Release card. Set carr for Fair Isle. Working in colour sequence as given in notes, inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 4th row 10(12,16,18,22,26) times in all, knit 2 rows*. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 3rd row 46(44,40,38,34, 30) times in all. 114 sts. Knit 3 rows. Row Counter 180(182,186,188,192,196). Carr at right.



Shape Shoulders

Set carr for partial knitting. Always With plain side of front facing, pick up taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, push 10 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next 6 rows. 54 Ns rem in B pos Break off yarn. Using a transfer tool bring all Ns in D pos back to B pos. Using col 1 knit 1 row stockinet. Push 30 Ns at left and right to D pos. 54 Ns rem in B pos. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Using a transfer tool bring 30 Ns at left from D pos back to B pos. Cast off. Using a transfer tool, bring rem 30 Ns from D pos back to B pos. Cast off.

FRONT FAIR ISLE PANEL

Foll instructions for Back Fair Isle Panel to *. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 3rd row 45(43,39,37,33,29) times in all. 112 sts. Knit 2 rows. Row Counter 176(178,182,184,188,192). Carr at right.

Shape Neck

Set carr for partial knitting. Push 72 Ns at left to D pos. Note row number showing on pattern panel.

Knit Right Part as follows:-


Always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, inc 1 st at beg of next row, knit 1 row. Push 3 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next and foll alt row.

Shape Shoulder

Push 10 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, 3 Ns on next row, 10 Ns on next row and 2 Ns on next row. **Push rem 10 Ns to D pos. Break off yarn. Carr at right. Set card to number previously noted and lock. Take carr to left. Using a transfer tool bring 40 Ns at alike) left from D pos back to B pos. Release card. Knit left part as for right part to **. Using a transfer tool, bring all Ns in D pos back to B pos. Using col 1, knit 1 row stockinet. Cast off 84 sts at right. 30 Ns rem. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine.

LEFT FRONT SHOULDER BAND

sts from below waste yarn on left shoulder and place onto Ns. Row Counter 000. Using col 2. Inc 1 st at right edge on the next 3 rows. Make buttonholes over Ns 6 & 7, 15 & 16, 24 & 25 (3 buttonholes altog). Inc 1 st at right edge on the next 3 rows. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next 3 rows. Make buttonholes over the same Ns as before. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next 3 rows. Knit 1 row. Cast off with waste yarn. Fold in half onto the outside and backstitch into pos.



RIGHT FRONT AND LEFT BACK SLEEVE AND SIDE PANELS (both

Push Ns 36 to 68 (36 to 70, 36 to 73, 36 to 75, 36 to 78, 36 to 80) inclusive at right of centre 0 to B pos. 33(35,38,40,43,45) Ns altog. Using waste yarn cast on and knit several rows ending with carr at left. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8. Using col 1, knit 4

at beg of next and ev foll alt row 18 times in all, knit 1 row. Cast on 45 sts at beg of next row. 133(135,138,140,143,145) sts. Row Counter 135. Carr at right. Knit 4(6,3,6,4,6) rows. Inc 1 st at left edge on next and ev foll 8th(8th,9th, 9th,10th,10th) row 6(6,6,6,6,7) times in all, knit 0(2,4,7,8,0) rows. Row Counter 180(184,188,194,198,202). Carr at left. Shape Front Edge

Set carr for partial knitting. Inc 1 st at left edge on the 8th(6th,5th,2nd,2nd, 10th) and ev foll 8th(8th,9th 9th,10th, 10th) row 4(4,4,4,4,3) times in all, AT THE SAME TIME, always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, push 8(8,8,8,9,9) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next and ev foll alt row 10(12,15,16,2,3) times in all, knit 1 row. Push 7(7,7,7,8,8) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next and ev foll alt row 8(6,3,2,16,15) times in all, knit 1 row. 7(7,7,8,7,8) Ns rem in B pos. Set russel levers to II. Using col 2, inc 1 st at right edge on next 6 rows. Dec 1 st at right edge on next 6 rows. Do not break yarn. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Leave Ns in B pos. Carr at left. With plain side of matching Fair Isle panel facing, pick up sts along diagonal edge and place onto Ns. With purl side of col 2 facing, place sts onto same Ns. Pick up alt sts from first row knitted in col 2 and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 10, knit 2 rows. Cast off with Linker.

LEFT FRONT AND RIGHT BACK SLEEVE AND SIDE PANELS (both alike)

Foll instructions for Right Front and Left Back Sleeve and Side Panels but reverse the shapings by reading left for right and vice versa.

COLLAR

Join right shoulder and upper sleeve seam (including hem). Push 61 Ns at left and 48 Ns at right of centre 0 to B pos. (109 Ns altog). Push the 4th and ev foll 3rd N back to A pos, ending with 3 Ns in B pos. With plain side facing, pick up sts around neck and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 4. Using col 1, knit 9 rows. Make a buttonhole over Ns 41,42 at right of centre 0. Knit 13 rows. Tension Dial at 5, knit 5 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Ns as before. Knit 18 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Ns as before, knit 2 rows. Tension Dial at 6, knit 16 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Special card (page 78 - HK160 Pattern Ns as before, knit 9 rows. Tension Dial at Collection)

rows. Inc 1 st at beg of next and ev foll 8, knit 1 row. Tension Dial at 6, knit 6th row 15 times in all, knit 1 row. 9 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Ns Inc 1 st at beg of next and ev foll alt row as before, knit 16 rows. Tension Dial at 4 times in all, knit 1 row. Cast on 2 sts 5, knit 2 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Ns as before. Knit 18 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Ns as before. Knit 5 rows. Tension Dial at 4, knit 13 rows. Make a buttonhole over same Ns as before. Knit 9 rows. Push empty Ns to B pos. Pick up a loop from adjacent st and place onto empty Ns. Tension Dial at 7, knit 1 row. Using waste yarn, knit 8 rows and release from machine.

WELTS

Push 104(110,116,122,128,134) Ns to B pos. Arrange Ns for 2x1 mock rib. With purl side facing, pick up sts along lower edge and place onto Ns. *Tension Dial at 5. Using col 1, knit 21 rows. Tension Dial at 8, knit 1 row. Tension Dial at 5, knit 21 rows. Push empty Ns to B pos. Pick up first row of welt and place onto corresponding Ns. Tension Dial at 10, knit 1 row. Cast off with Linker*.

CUFFS

Join left upper sleeve seam. Push 47(50, 53,56,59,62) Ns to B pos. Arrange Ns for 2x1 mock rib. With purl side of sleeve facing, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns gathering evenly. Work as for welts from *to*. Remove waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join side and sleeve seams. Fold collar in half onto outside and backstitch into pos. Remove waste yarn. Join left shoulder band and left hem. Finish buttonholes and sew on buttons to correspond. Finish hem edges. Give final light steam.

SLASHED NECK SWEATER WITH FAIR ISLE CHEVRONS

SIZE:

To fit 81-86(91-96) cms/32-34(36-38) inch bust.

MATERIALS:

Double Knitting

400 (450) grms in col 1 (grey)

100 grms in col 2 (black)

100 grms in col 3 (yellow)

100 grms in col 4 (red)

50 grms in col 5 (turquoise)

TENSIONS:

25 sts and 36 rows to 10 cms measured over stockinet. Tension Dial at approximately 8.

26 sts and 32 rows to 10 cms measured over Fair Isle pattern. Tension Dial at approximately 8.

ABBREVIATIONS:

See page 1.

NOTES:

Figures in brackets refer to the larger sizes respectively. All increasings should be worked by using a single transfer tool and moving the end st 1 N out, then pick up loop below adjacent st and place onto empty N. All decreasings should be worked by using a double transfer tool and moving the 2 end sts 1 N in.

Fair Isle Pattern

With col 2 in feeder 1 and col 4 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows.

With col 2 in feeder 1 and col 5 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows.

With col 2 in feeder 1 and col 3 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows.

FAIR ISLE PANELS (both alike)

Insert special card into machine and lock on row 1. Push 1 N at left and right of centre 0 to B pos. (2 Ns altog). Using col 2 cast on by hand. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8, knit 2 rows. Release card. Set carr for Fair Isle. Working in colour sequence as given in notes, inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 4th row 11 times in all, knit 3 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 3rd row 18 times in all. 60 sts. Knit 2 rows. Row Counter 100. Carr at right.

Divide for V insert


Using ravel cord hold 30 sts at left. Note row number showing on pattern panel.


Knit Right Part as follows:-

Inc 1 st at right edge and dec 1 st at left edge on next and ev foll 3rd row 27 times in all. Carr at left.

Shape Shoulder

Set carr for partial knitting. Always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, push 5 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos, dec 1 st at beg of next row, knit 1 row. Push 5 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row. Dec 1 st at left edge on next row. Push 5 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next and foll alt row, knit 1 row. 3 Ns rem in B pos. Using a transfer tool, bring Ns in D pos back to B pos, cast off. Carr at right. Set card to number previously





noted and lock. Take carr to left. Undo edge of next row. Push 2 Ns at opposite versa.

BACK V INSERT

Using col 1 cast on 2 sts by hand. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8, knit 1 row. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 4th row 20 times in all, knit 3 rows*. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 3rd row 7 times in all, 56 sts. Knit 2 rows. Row Counter 102. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine.

FRONT V INSERT

Foll instructions for Back to *. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 3rd row 3 times in all. 48 sts. Knit 1 row. Row Counter 89. Carr at left.

Shape Neck

Set carr for partial knitting. Push 39 Ns at right to D pos.

Knit Left Part as follows:-

Always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, knit 1 row. Inc 1 st at left edge on next row. Push 2 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 2 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos, inc 1 st at beg of next row, knit 1 row. Push 2 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row. Inc 1 st at left

ravel cord bringing Ns back to B pos. end to carr to D pos on next row, knit Release card. Knit left part as for right 1 row. Push 2 Ns at opposite end to part but read left for right and vice carr to D pos, inc 1 st at beg of next row, knit 1 row**. Push rem 3 Ns to D pos. Break off yarn. Carr at right. Using a transfer tool bring 9 Ns at right from D pos back to B pos. Knit right part as for left part to ** but read right for left. Push all Ns from D pos back to C pos, knit 1 row. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine.

> LEFT BACK AND RIGHT FRONT 'OFF CENTRE' PANELS (both alike) Push 30 Ns to B pos. Using waste yarn cast on and knit several rows ending with carr at right. Row Counter 000.

Tension Dial at 8. Using col 1, knit 1 row. Inc 1 st at right edge and dec 1 st at left edge on next and ev foll 3rd row 6 times in all, knit 2 rows. Inc 1 st at right edge and dec 1 st at left edge on next and ev foll 4th row 24 times in all, knit 2 rows. Row Counter 114. Carr at right.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next row. Dec 1 st at left edge on next and ev foll 4th row 23 times in all. Cast off rem 2 sts.


RIGHT BACK AND LEFT FRONT 'OFF CENTRE' PANELS (both alike) Foll instructions for Left Back and Right Front off centre Panels but reverse the shapings by reading right for left and left for right.

SIDE PANELS

Push 66(78) Ns to B pos. Using waste yarn cast on and knit several rows ending with carr at right. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8. Mark centre with waste yarn. Using col 1, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 4th row 21 times in all, knit 3 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of next and ev foll 3rd row 10 times in all. 4(16) sts. Knit 1 row. Row Counter 114. Cast off.

SLEEVES

Push 66 Ns at left and 48(54) Ns at right of centre 0 to B pos. (114(120) Ns altog). Using waste yarn cast on and knit several rows ending with carr at left. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8. Using col 1, knit 1 row. Set carr for partial knitting. Always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, push 108 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. *Push 6 inside Ns at opposite end to carr from D pos to C pos, inc 1 st at beg of next row, knit 1 row. Push 6 inside Ns at opposite end to carr from D pos to C pos on next row, knit 1 row*. Rept from *to* 8 more times. Inc 1 st at beg of next and



sts. Knit 15 rows. Using col 4, knit 12 rows. Pick up loops from last row knitted in col 1 and place onto Ns. Using col 1, knit 16 rows. Dec 1 st at beg of next first row knitted in col 5 and place onto and ev foll 4th row 9 times in all, knit 1 row. *Push 6 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 6 Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos, dec 1 st at beg of next row, knit 1 row*. Rept from *to* 8 more times. Push 108 Ns at opposite end to carr from D pos to C pos on next row. Using waste yarn, knit 8 rows and release from machine. Knit second sleeve as for first sleeve but reverse the shapings by reading left for right and vice versa.

HEM TO JOIN SIDE PANELS TO OFF CENTRE PANELS (4 alike)

Push 76 Ns to B pos. With carr at left and purl side of side panel facing, pick up sts along one diagonal edge and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 8. Using col 4, knit 12 rows. Do not break yarn. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Leave Ns in B pos. Carr at left. With plain side of matching off centre panel facing, pick up sts along short diagonal edge and place onto Ns. With purl side of col 4 facing, place sts onto same Ns. Pick up alt sts from first row knitted in col 4 and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 10, knit 2 rows. Cast off using Linker.

HEM TO JOIN OFF CENTRE PANELS TO FAIR ISLE PANELS (4 alike)

Push 140 Ns to B pos. With carr at left and purl side of off centre panel facing, pick up sts along long diagonal edge and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 8. Using col 3, knit 12 rows. Do not break yarn. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Leave Ns in B pos. Carr at left. With plain side of Fair Isle Panel facing, pick up sts along matching long diagonal edge and place onto Ns. With purl side of col 3 facing, place sts onto same Ns. Pick up alt sts from first row knitted in col 3 and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 10, knit 2 rows. Cast off using Linker.

HEM TO JOIN FAIR ISLE PANELS TO V INSERTS (4 alike)

Push 66 Ns to B pos. With carr at left and purl side of Fair Isle Panel facing, pick up sts along one short diagonal edge and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 8. Using col 5, inc 1 st at V on next 6 rows. Dec 1 st at V on next 6 rows. Do not break yarn. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Leave Ns in B pos. Carr at left. With plain side of

ev foll 4th row 9 times in all. 132(138) V insert facing, pick up sts along matching diagonal edge and place onto Ns. With purl side of col 5 facing, place sts onto same Ns. Pick up alt sts from Ns. Tension Dial at 10, knit 2 rows. Cast off using Linker.

WELTS

Push 110(122) Ns to B pos. Arrange Ns for 2x1 mock rib. With purl side facing, pick up sts between marked points and place onto Ns gathering evenly. *Tension Dial at 5. Using col 1, knit 21 rows. Tension Dial at 8, knit 1 row. Tension Dial at 5, knit 21 rows. Push empty Ns to B pos. Pick up a loop from adjacent st and place onto empty Ns. Tension Dial at 10, knit 1 row. Cast off using Linker*. Remove waste yarn.

CUFFS

Push 50(56) Ns to B pos. Arrange Ns for 2x1 mock rib. With purl side of sleeve facing, pick up sts and place onto Ns. Work as for Welts from *to*.

NECKBAND (2 pieces)

Push 56 Ns to B pos. With plain side facing, pick up sts and place onto Ns. Tension Dial at 5. Using col 3, dec 1 st at both ends of next 6 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of next 6 rows. Knit 1 row. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder and neckband seams (including hems). Set in sleeves. Graft sleeve seams. Join welt and cuff seams, fold in half and catch down on inside. Join ends of hems at V. Fold neckband in half onto the outside and backstitch into pos. Remove waste yarn. Give final light steam.

BATWING SHAWL COLLAR JACKET

SIZES:

To fit 81-106 cms/32-42 inch bust.


MATERIALS:

Double Knitting 550(600,650,700,750,800) grms in col 1 (black) 275(325,375,425,515,625) grms in col 2 (turquoise) 2 buttons; 4 press studs

TENSION:

25 sts and 32 rows to 10 cms measured

Finish with 2 rows of holes

over Fair Isle. Tension Dial at approximately 8.




LEFT BACK

Insert special card the right way round into the machine and lock on row 1. Push 55(58,61,64,67,70) Ns at right of centre 0 to B pos. Using col 1 cast on by hand. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 7, knit 11 rows. Tension Dial at 10, knit 1 row. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8. Release card. Set carr for Fair Isle. With col 1 in feeder 1 and col 2 in feeder 2, knit 55(51,47,45,41,39) rows. Mark right edge with waste yarn. Note pattern row on card for sleeves. Knit 156(160,164,166,170,172) rows. Row Counter 211. Carr at left.

Shape Shoulder

Set carr for partial knitting. Always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, push 5(6,6,7,7,8) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(6,6,7,7,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(6,6,6,7,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row.





Push 5(5,6,6,7,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next and foll alt row, knit 1 row. Push 5(5,6,6,6,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(5,5,6,6,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. 20 Ns rem in B pos. Set carr for stockinet. Push Ns from D pos to C pos. Tension Dial at 10, using col 1, knit 1 row. Cast off with Linker.

RIGHT BACK

Insert special card back to front into the machine and lock on row 1. Work as given for Left back but reverse the shapings by reading right for left and vice versa.

RIGHT FRONT

Insert special card the right way round into the machine and lock on row 1. Push 28 Ns at left and 55(58,61,64,67, 70) Ns at right of centre 0 to B pos. (83(86,89,92,95,98) Ns altog). Using col 1 cast on by hand. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 7, knit 11 rows. Tension Dial at 10, knit 1 row. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 8. Release card. Set carr for Fair Isle. With col 1 in feeder 1 and col 2 in feeder 2, knit 6 rows. Mark left edge with waste yarn. Knit 49(45,41,39,35,33) rows. Mark right edge with waste yarn. Knit 156(160,164,166,170,172) rows. Row

Counter 211. Carr at left.

Shape Shoulder

Set carr for partial knitting. Always taking yarn round first inside N in D pos. Push 5(6,6,7,7,8) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(6,6,7,7,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(6,6,6,7,7,) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(5,6,6,7,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos on next and foll alt row, knit 1 row. Push 5(5,6,6,6,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos, cast off 3(3,3,2,2,1) sts at beg of next row, knit 1 row. Push 5(5,5,6,6,7) Ns at opposite end to carr to D pos, cast off 5(5,5,6,6,7) sts at beg of next row, knit 1 row. 40 Ns rem in B pos. Without taking yarn round first inside N in D pos, knit 29 rows without shaping. Set carr for stockinet. Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Push Ns from D pos to C pos. Tension Dial at 10, using col 1, knit

LEFT FRONT



Insert special card the right way round into the machine and lock on row previously noted on Left Back. Work as given for Left Front and Right Back Sleeves but reverse the shapings by reading right for left and vice versa.



TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join centre back, shoulder and upper sleeve seams. Set in sleeves between marked points. Join side and under sleeve seams. Turn up hem at lower edge and catch down on the inside. Graft sts at back neck. Sew under collar into pos. Sew press studs inside to fasten. Sew on buttons as shown.

Release card. Set carr for Fair Isle. Working in colour sequence as given in notes, knit 4 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 4th row 45 times in all. 160 sts. Knit 3 rows without shaping. Row Counter 184. Mark centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

COLLAR

Join one shoulder seam.

Push 146 Ns to B pos. Arrange Ns for 2x1 rib. With plain side facing, pick up along one front edge and across back of neck and place onto Ns in B pos. *Tension Dial at 1. Set russel levers to 11 and push Ns

to D pos on ev row. Using col 1, knit 33 rows. Tension Dial at 3, knit 1 row. Tension Dial at 1, knit 33 rows. Push empty Ns to B pos. Pick up a loop from adjacent st and place onto empty Ns. Tension Dial at 5, knit 1 row. Using waste yarn, knit 8 rows and release from machine*.

2nd Piece

Push 74 Ns to B pos. Arrange Ns for 2x1

rib. With plain side facing, pick up along onto the outside. Pin into pos and backsecond front edge and place onto Ns in B pos. Work as given for 1st Piece from *to*.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join remaining shoulder and collar seam, Set in sleeves between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Fold collar in half

stitch through the open loops of last row knitted in col 1. Overlap ends of collar and sew into pos.

What Next?

I hope that by the time you reach this page, you'll have knitted your way through the Free beginner's patterns, and at least a couple of the tops featured in this book. You should be feeling quite confident and happy with your Knitmaster Handknitter, and asking yourself, "Right, what shall I knit next?"

Well, you could have a look at the pattern book which Knitmaster and Emu produced especially for the Handknitter. This contains twelve patterns, which are a good mix of men's, women's and children's tops, and some are knitted in tuck or slip stitch. It's a good idea to knit up quite a few woollies on a new machine, to really get a feel for it, and so you know exactly what you're doing.

Have Fun with Yarn and Punchcards!

Perhaps you're eager to get on to the next stage, and you're not quite sure how to go about it. You might like to concentrate on just one aspect of machine knitting. You could start experimenting with yarn and colour, or with stitch patterns, or with garment shapes. Let's start with yarn first of all. Knitmaster Kone has been developed by the experts for machine knitters, so it really is the ideal yarn to use. Probably all the garments you've knitted so far have been in 4 ply. Why not try something thinner, or even thicker? Knitmaster Kone also comes in 2 ply, and an aran weight. Treat yourself to a couple of Kones - sorry, cones - of each - there are some lovely colours available, and try a Fair Isle pattern in 2 ply and Aran. Or how about a tuck stitch pattern in 2 ply? Use the punch cards which come with the machine. Try card 703. Lock the card on row 7 and knit six rows 2 ply, turn the cam lever back to stockinet and knit two rows Aran. Keep repeating this, or lock the card on a dif-

ferent row for each section of tuck stitch. Mix different textures of yarn together, for example, mohair and Kone 4 ply, like the two ladies sweaters on the back cover.

Be a D.I.Y. Designer

The next step after this could be to try punching out your own designs onto blank cards. Your Knitmaster stockist can supply a handy punch and blank cards specially for your Handknitter. If you're feeling a bit nervous to start with, there is a book full of punchcard designs, just for your machine. It's called Lecle, and is full of designs for Fair Isle, slip and tuck stitch. Why not choose a Fair Isle design,

cable and lace patterns. Using these techniques as a starting point, see how many variations you can think of. How about doing cables and lace all in the same piece.

Knit your favourite Stitch Patterns

Now, you've assembled lots of swatches and ideas, which, incidentally have all given you plenty of practice on your Handknitter, so the next stage is to take all these ideas - and turn them into a garment. One way to do this is to find a written pattern with the same number of stitches and rows to 10cm, as you read from your new tension square. Then, if


and punch a new card for the child's sweater on the back cover? All you have to do is make sure that you get the same number of stitches and rows with your new card as the original pattern tells you, and the sweater will have a completely new look.

Knit your Favourite shapes

You've probably found out by now that unless you can get exactly the same tension as a pattern says, the garment you knit can be quite disastrous! Fortunately,

there is a way round this, which means you can knit any shape you like, in your own choice of yarn and stitch pattern. Knitmaster produce an attachment called a KR6 Knitradar, which is available through your local stockist. This sits on the back of your Handknitter, and a diagram shows you how many stitches to cast on, and exactly where to increase and decrease.

Start by knitting a tension square exactly as your instruction book tells you. Use the green ruler to measure the stitches and rows. Set the Knitradar with this information, choose the garment shape you want from the set supplied free, and off you go! Using the Knitradar means you don't ever have to search around for patterns the size and shape with the Knitradar cover men's, women's you'd like to knit other types of stitch and children's garments in a range of sizes, and because you can see the shape you're going to knit, it's really easy to alter it.

Your local Knitmaster stockist can supply you with some useful accessories

you can even make your own patterns, starting from scratch. Put all these ideas and accessories together, and I can guarantee that you'll never see anyone else in knitwear like yours! Another accessory you'll find really useful is the SC7 linker. This will cast off, and also help you put you've more than doubled your choice of your garments together quickly, and with a really professional finish. You can also use it to do some really interesting patterns on the surface of your knitting. Use thirty new punchcards, and the same it to turn a plain stockinet sweater into Knitradar will fit on this machine. something unique.




