

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
### HOW TO SHAPE A NECK LINE IN PATTERN KNITTING (K CARRIAGE..... Fair-isle, Tuck-stitch, Plating-tuck stitch and multicolour rib pattern)

### A. With waste knitting

1. Push "CR" key before changing the direction of the K carriage. (Error lamp goes on and off.)

### \* < REMARKS > \*

If you changed the direction of K carriage before pushing "CR" key, enter "1" instead of "0" and push "CR" key at item 6.




2. Knit the second side of the shoulder with waste yarn.




1) Set the change knob to the "N.L".


Bring back all the selected needles to position B.



2) Push both "PART" buttons and move the K carriage to the opposite side of the machine without yarn in the yarn feeder. (When using the knit-leader and/or the row counter, set the row counter tripper to the non-working position.)




Bring forward all the needles for the first side of the shoulder to position E.




4) Set the holding cam lever to position H.

- 5) Knit the second side of the shoulder in plain knitting with waste yarn.
- After knitting several rows, take them off the machine.




Using the transfer tool, place the stitches for the first side of the shoulder onto the hooks of the needles and return them to position B.

Place the K carriage at the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark.




Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or KC (II)" and push both "PART" buttons.




If you changed the direction of K carriage before pushing "CR" key, enter "1" instead of "0" and



8. Change the figure of the row counter to "O" and set the row counter tripper to working position.






7. Move the K carriage from the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark until the needles are selected. (When the K carriage is on the opposite side of the yarn, needles will be selected after one row, and when the K carriage is at the side of the yarn, needles will be selected after two rows.)

In the latter case, if you are setting the change knob at "KC (I)", push back both end needles to position B by hand after the first row, then move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.




 Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and thread the knitting yarn into the yarn feeder. 11. Knit the first side of the shoulder according to the pattern.




13. Pick up the stitches for the second side of the shoulder and hook them onto the needles. After picking up the stitches, bring back all the needles to position B.




 Push both "PART" buttons. (Make sure that the change knob is set on position "KC (I)" or "KC (II)".




17. Make sure that the reference mark in the L window is returned to the card inlet.



12. After knitting the first side of the shoulder, place the K carriage on the side toward which the K carriage was moved. (Leave the setting of the K carriage as it is.)



14. Enter the figure which shows on the row counter and push "CR" key.




16. Move the K carriage from the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark until the needles are selected. (If you are setting the change knob at "KC (I)", push back both end needles to position B by hand after the first row, then move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)




18. Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and thread the knitting yarn into the yarn feeder. Knit the second side of the shoulder according to the pattern.


### B. Using the holding cam lever




 Change the figure of the row counter to "O" and set the row counter tripper to working position.




 Set the holding cam lever to position H and bring forward all the needles on the opposite side of the K carriage including the stitches for the center neck line and opposite shoulder to position E. (These needles will not knit.)



After knitting the first side of the shoulder, place the K carriage on the side toward which the K carriage was moved. (Leave the setting of the K carriage as it is.)




7. Enter the figure which shows in the row counter and push the "CR" key.



Put the reference mark in the L window at the card inlet.


4. Knit the first side of the shoulder according to the pattern.



Leave the stitches for the center neck line in position E, place the stitches for the second side of the shoulder onto the hooks of the needles and return to position B.




 Push both "PART" buttons. (Make sure that the change knob is set on the position "KC (I)" or "KC (II)".




9. Move the K carriage from the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark until the needles are selected.


(If you are setting the change knob at "KC (I)", push back both end needles to position B by hand after first row, then move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)



11. Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and thread the knitting yarn into the yarn feeder. Knit the second side of the shoulder according to the pattern.




Make sure that the reference mark in the L window is returned to the card inlet.




12. When both sides of the shoulders are completed. Place the stitches for center neck line onto the hooks of needles and bind them off. HOW TO CORRECT MISTAKES IN PATTERN KNITTING (K CARRIAGE..... Fair-isle, Tuck-stitch, Skip-stitch, Plating-tuck stitch and Multi-colour rib pattern.)

### A. If the K carriage should jam.

\*Do not move the K carriage by force.




1. Push "CR" key. (Error lamp goes on and off.)




Take the yarn out of the yarn feeder. (When knitting fair-isle, weaving or plating-tuck stitch pattern, also take the second yarn out of the yarn feeder.)




Loosen the knobs and remove the sinker plate assembly from the K carriage.



3. Set the change knob to the "CR" to release the K carriage from the machine.




Lift the K carriage to remove, and place it at the outside of "I  $\subset$  " or "I" mark.



 Set the change knob to the "N.L". (The cam button(s) will be restored automatically.)



Return the sinker plate assembly to the K carriage.



If the stitches are on the stem of the needles, transfer them to the hooks of the needles by using the transfer tool.

Unravelling a row of knitting.

(When knitting fair-isle, weaving or plating-tuck stitch pattern, unravel the second colour yarn too.)

When unravelling several rows, bear the unravelled rows in mind.


(Even if you unravel one stitch, it must be counted as one row.)



 Push both "PART" buttons and set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)".




- 11. Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern.
- When using the knit-leader and/or the row counter, set the row counter tripper to the working position.



- Enter the figure for unravelled row, and push "CR" key. (Pattern card will be returned to the correct row of the pattern automatically.)
- Turn back the feeding dial of knit-leader and the row counter by the same number of rows unravelled.

(There is no need to turn them back if they are not fed forward by the row counter tripper.)
Set the row counter tripper to the non-working position.



10. Move the K carriage from the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark until the needles are selected. (If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)




Thread the knitting yarn into the yarn feeder, and continue to knit the pattern. B. When unravelling several rows of a swatch. (K carriage is outside of the swatch.)


 Unravelling a swatch. (Bear the unravelled rows in mind.)

Turn back the feeding dial of knit-leader and the row counter by the same number of rows unravelled.


Set the row counter tripper to the non-working position.




- 5. Move the K carriage from the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark until the needles are selected. (If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)


 Enter the figure for the unravelled row, and push the "CR" key.

- When using the knit-leader and/or the row counter, set the row counter tripper to the nonworking position.




- 5. Move the K carriage from the outside of "I ⊂ " or "I" mark until the needles are selected. (If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)
- 7. When using the knit-leader and/or the row counter, set the row counter tripper to the working position.







### HOW TO SHAPE A NECK LINE IN PATTERN KNITTING (L CARRIAGE..... Normal-lace and finelace pattern)

### A. With the waste knitting.

 Place the K carriage on the right side of the machine. (If the K carriage is on the left side of the machine at the neck point, knit one more row to the right.)




2. Put the reference mark beside the L window of the pattern card at the card inlet.

3. Knit the left side of the shoulder with waste yarn.



Push both "PART" buttons and move the K carriage to the opposite side of the machine without the yarn in the yarn feeder.
 (When using the knit-leader and/or the row counter, set the row counter tripper to the non-working position.)




2) Bring forward all the needles for the right side of the shoulder to position E.




Set the holding cam lever to position H, knit the left side of the shoulder in plain knitting with waste yarn.

4) After knitting several rows, take them off the machine.



 Using the transfer tool, place all the stitches for the right side of the shoulder onto the hooks of the needles and return them to postion B.


- 5. Thread the knitting yarn into the yarn feeder.
- Knit the right side of the shoulder by operating the L and K carriages according to the pattern.
- 7. Pick up the stitches for the left side of the shoulder and hook them onto the needles. After picking up the stitches, push back all the needles to position B.




- Push "RR" key. (Pattern card returns to the set line.)
- B. Using the cast-on thread.
- 1. Place the K carrage on the right side of the machine.

(If the K carriage is on the left side of the machine at the neck point, knit one more row to the right.)


3. Knit the right side of the shoulder first.




- 1) Bring forward all the needles for the left side of the shoulder including the stitches for the center neck line to position E.
- Knit the right side of the shoulder by operating the L and K carriages according to the pattern.
- 5. Transfer all the stitches for the left side of the shoulder from the needles in position A to the hooks of the needles and place them in position B. (Leave all the stitches for the center neck line as they are.)



- Enter the figure of the reference mark which is shown beside the L window of the pattern card and push "CF" key.
- Knit the left side of the shoulder by operating the L and K carriages according to the pattern.







2) Lay the cast-on thread on the hooks of the needles in position E and push them back to position A one by one.

(At this time, make sure that the cast-on thread is between hook and latch of the needle to avoid dropping stitches.)






Push "RR" key. (Pattern card returns to the set line.)



 Transfer all the stitches for the center neck line from the needles in position A to the hooks of the needles and place them in position B, then bind them off.




 Enter the figure of the reference mark which is shown beside the L window of the pattern card and push "CF" key.

8. Knit the left side of the shoulder by operating the L and K carriages according to the pattern.

### HOW TO CORRECT MISTAKES IN PATTERN KNITTING. (L CARRIAGE.....Normal-lace and fine-lace pattern)

### A. If the L carriage should jam.


\* Do not move the L carriage by force.




 Put the reference mark beside the L window of the pattern card at the card inlet.



3. Pull the release button towards you and remove the L carriage.




2. Push "RR" key. (Pattern card returns to the set line.)




Pull the release button and place the L carriage firmly on the left extension rail.


4. Transfer all the stitches back to plain knitting. Plain knitting.




 If needles get caught with each other, replace them by lifting tips.






## 3. Unravelling a row of knitting.



- 1) Return the transferred stitches to the adjacent needles and align all the needles in position B. (Return the stitches back to plain knitting.)
- 2) Unravel two rows.
- 3) Unravelling necessary rows by repeating these steps 1) and 2).
- At this time, bear in mind how many times you returned the stitches back to plain knitting.

5. Continue to knit by operating the L and K carriages according to the marks ( ) in the L windows of the pattern card.







4. Find the row number of the mark ( ) in the L window below your checking mark according to the times you replaced the stitches to plain knitting. If you replaced the stitches to plain kniting 3 times, you have to read the row number of 3 marks below from your checking mark.

Enter the figure for the row number of the mark ( ) and push "CF" key. (Pattern card will be fed to the correct row of the pattern automatically.)


- C. If you operate L carrage for one extra row.
  - 1. Bring back all the selected needles to position B.




- 3. Enter "2" and push "CR" key.
- D. If the needle selection is broken by mistake. Make the same needle selection again.
- 1. Align all the needles in position B.




- 2. Enter "1" and push "CR" key.
- E. If you knit an extra row without any operation of the L carriage. When some needles are selected.
- 1. Unravelling the extra row of knitting.
- 2. Align all the needles in position B.





- Move the L carriage to the left side of the machine and place it outside of the "I ⊂ " mark.
- 4. Knit 2 rows with the K carriage. (When L carriage moves from right to left, needles are sometimes selected. If so, you can leave them as they are.)
- Continue to knit by operating the L and K carriages according to the marks ( ) in the L window of the patterns card.



- Operate the L carriage across and back. (Needles will be selected after the second row.)
- Continue to knit by operating the L and K carriages according to the mark ( ) in the L window of the pattern card.



- Operate the L carriage across and back. (Needles will be selected after the second row.)
- Continue to knit by operating the L and K carriages according to the marks ( ) in the L window of the pattern card.

### IF YOU CAN NOT REMEMBER THE NUMBER OF ROWS UNRAVELLED WHEN CORRECT-ING MISTAKES IN PATTERN KNITTING

### PATTERN KNITTING ..... K CARRIAGE

1. When the error lamp goes on and off, push "CE" key. (Error lamp goes out.)

2. Set the change knob to "KC(I)" or "KC(II)". Move the K carriage from the outside of the turn mark("1 ⊂ " or "I") and pass it to the turn mark ("I ⊂ " or "I")' Then, replace the K carriage on the extension rail at the starting side.

3. Push "RR" key. (Pattern card returns to the set line.)

4. Set the change knob to "N.L" and push both "PART" buttons.

5. Check the pattern swatch and find the row number of the next knitting row on the pattern card. (This instruction applies to all combinations of pattern variation switches except when using the KRC (NO.7) switch.)

After this, follow the instructions according to the combination of pattern variation switches.

### A. When the double length (No. 4), the reflection (No. 5) and the KRC (No. 7) switches are not in use.

1. Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I ⊂ " or "I") at the opposite side of the yarn.

2. Enter the figure of next knitting row and push "CF" key.

- 3. Set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles.
- 4. Push cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

### B. When useing the double length (No. 4) switch.

Double length pattern knits the same row of the pattern twice.

Check and find that whether the next knitting row is the first row or the second row of the double length pattern.

1. If the next knitting row is the first row of the double length pattern.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I at the opposite side of the yarn.

2) Enter the figure of the next knitting row and push "CF" key.

- 3) Set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I C " or "I" mark to select the needles.
- 4) Push cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

2. If the next knitting row is the second row of the double length pattern.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I C " or "I") at the side of the yarn.

2) Enter the row number which is above the next knitting row and push "CF" key.

3) Enter "0" and push "CR" key.
4) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles.

(If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)

5) Push cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

### C. When using the reflection (No. 5) switch.

Check and find the knitting direction of pattern.

- \* When you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top, the next kniting row is the above row of the corresponding
- When you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom, the next knitting row is the below row of the corresponding

1. If you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark("I < " or "I") at the opposite side of the yarn.

2) Push "CF" key.

3) Enter the figure of the next (above) knitting row and push "CF" key.

- 4) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles.
- 5) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.
- 2. If you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom.
  - 1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I ⊂ " or "I") at the opposite side of the yarn.
  - 2) Enter the last (top) row number of the pattern which is selected from the pattern card and push "CF" key.
  - 3) Enter the figure of the next (below) knitting row and push "CF" key.
  - 4) Set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles.
  - 5) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

D. When using the double length (No. 4) and the reflection (NO. 5) switches.

- Check and find the knitting direction of the pattern and whether it is the first row or the second row of the double length pattern.
- \* When you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top, the next knitting row is the row above the corresponding
- \* When you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom, the next knitting row is the row below the corresponding row.
- 1. If you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top and the next knitting row is the first row of the double length pattern.
  - 1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I ⊂ " or "I") at the opposite side of the yarn.
  - 2) Reset the double length (No. 4) switch to the lower position.
  - 3) Push "CF:" key.
  - 4) Set the double length (No. 4) switch to the upper position.
  - 5) Enter the figure of the next (above) knitting row and push "CF" key.
  - 6) Set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles.
  - 7) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.
- 2. If you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom and the next knitting row is the first row of the double length pattern.
  - 1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I ⊂ " or "I") at the opposite side of the yarn.
  - 2) Reset the double length (No. 4) switch to the lower position.
  - 3) Enter the last (top) row number of the pattern which is selected from the pattern card and push "CF" key.
  - 4) Set the double length (No. 4) switch to the upper position.
  - 5) Enter the figure of the next (below) knitting row and push "CF" key.
  - 6) Set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles.
  - 7) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.
- 3. If you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top and the next knitting row is the second row of the double length pattern.
  - 1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the turn mark ("I C " or "I") at the side of the yarn.
  - 2) Reset the double length (No. 4) switch to the lower position.
  - 3) Push "CF" key.
  - 4) Set the double length (No. 4) switch to the upper position.
  - 5) Enter the row number which is above the next knitting row and push "CF" key.
  - 6) Enter "0" and push "CR" key.
  - 7) Set the change knob to the "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " or "I" mark to select the needles. (If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)
  - 8) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

### F. When using the KRC (No. 7) and the double length (No. 4) switches.

\* Check the stitches which are on the needles and find the corresponding row number of pattern on the pattern card.

\* Mark the row number which is above the corrresponding row number of the pattern.

\* If you find the corresponding row nomber on the pattern card and it is the last(top) row of the pattern, the next row is the first (bottom) row of the pattern.

Check the last unravelled row and find that whether it is the main yarn or contrast yarn.

- 1. If the last unravelled row is the main yarn and it is on the left side of the swatch.
  - 1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the left turn mark "I 
    ".
  - 2) Enter the figure of the marked row number and push the "CF" key.

3) Enter "0" and push "CR" key.

4) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I " mark to select the needles.

(If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)

5) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

2. If the last unravelled row is the main yarn and it is on the right side of the swatch.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the left turn mark "I ⊂ ".

2) Enter the figure of the marked row number and push "CF" key.

- 3) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " mark to select the needles.
- 4) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.
- 3. If the last unravelled row is the contrast yarn and it is on the left side of the swatch.

Place the K carriage on the outside of the left turn mark "I ⊂ ".
 Enter the figure of the marked row number and push "CF" key.

3) Enter "2" and push the "CR" key.

4) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " mark to select the needles.

(If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)

5) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

4. If the last unravelled row is the contrast yarn and it is on the right side of the swatch.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the right turn mark "I".

2) Enter the figure of the marked row number and push the "CF" key.

3) Enter "1" and "CR" key.

4) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I" mark to select the needles.

(If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)

5) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

### G. When using the KRC (No. 7) and the reflection (No. 5) switches.

Check the knitting direction of the pattern.

Check the stitches which are on the needles and find the corresponding row of pattern on the pattern card.

Mark the row number which is next to the corresponding row number of pattern.

- When you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top, the next knitting row is the row above the corresponding row.
- When you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom, the next knitting row is the row below the corresponding row.
- \* If you find the corresponding row number on the pattern card and it is the first(bottom) row of the pattern, the next row is the second row from the bottom of the pattern. If it is the last (top) row of the pattern, the next row is the second row from the top of the pattern.

Check the last unravelled row and find that whether it is the main yarn or the contrast yarn.

### G-I. When you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top.

- If the last unravelled row is the main yarn and it is on the left side of the swatch.

  - 3) Push "CF" key.
  - 4) Set the KRC (No. 7) switch to the upper position.
  - 5) Enter the figure of the marked row number and push the "CF" key.
  - 6) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " mark to select the needles.
  - 7) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.
- 3. If the last unravelled row is the contrast yarn and it is on the left side of the swatch.
  - 1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the left turn mark "I ⊂ ".
  - 2) Reset the KRC (No. 7) switch to the lower position.
  - 3) Push "CF" Key.
  - 4) Set the KRC (No. 7) switch to the upper position.
  - 5) Enter the figure which is above the marked row number and push the "CF" key.
  - 6) Enter "2" and push the "CR" key.
  - 7) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the oustside of the "I ⊂ " mark to select the needles.
    - (If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)
  - 8) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

4. If the last unravelled row is the contrast yarn and it is on the right side of the swatch.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the right turn mark "I".

2) Reset the KRC (No. 7) switch to the lower position.

3) Push "CF" key.

- 4) Set the KRC (No. 7) switch to the upper position.

### G-II. When you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom.

6) Enter "0" push the "CR" key.

7) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " mark to select the needles.

(If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)

- 8) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.
- 2. If the last unravelled row is the main yarn and it is on the right side of the swatch.

1) Place the K carriage on the outside of the left turn mark "I ⊂ ".

5) Enter the figure which is below the marked row number and push the "CF" key.

6) Enter "2" and push the "CF" key.

7) Set the change knob to "KC (I)" or "KC (II)" and move the K carriage from the outside of the "I ⊂ " mark to select the needles.

(If both end needles are selected after the first row, push them back to position B by hand and move the K carriage for one more row to select the needles.)

8) Push the cam button(s) according to the pattern knitting and continue to knit.

### H. When using the KRC (No. 7), the double length (No. 4) and the reflection (No. 5) switches.

\* Check the knitting direction of the pattern.

Check the stitches which are on the needles and find the corresponding row of the pattern on the pattern card.

\* Mark the row number which is next to the corresponding row number of the pattern.

\* When you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top, the next row is the row above the corresponding row.

When you are knitting the pattern from top to bottom, the next row is the row below corresponding row.

\* If you find the corresponding row number on the pattern card and it is the first (bottom) row of the pattern, the next row is the second row from the bottom of the pattern. If it is the last (top) row of the pattern, the next row is the second row from the top of the pattern.

Check the last unravelled row and find that whether it is the main yarn or the contrast yarn.

### H-I. When you are knitting the pattern from bottom to top.

1. If the last unravelled row is the main yarn and it is on the left side of the swatch.

Place the K carriage on the outside of the left turn mark "I ⊂ ".
