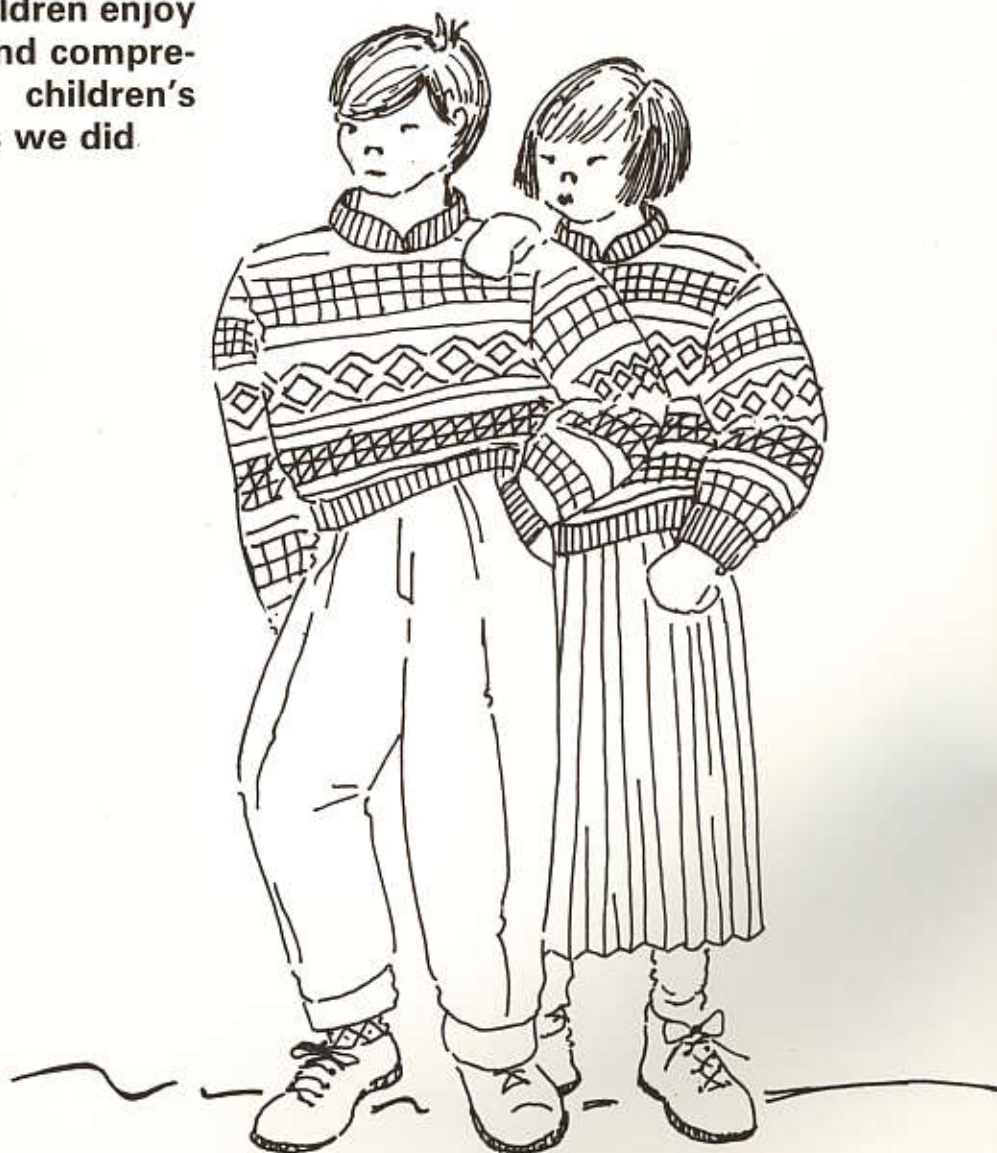
The *Kiddies* *Chunky* Book

1 STRIPED ROLL NECK SWEATER



Children are more than capable of using today's easy-to-operate knitting machines but often find that the usual form of knitting pattern, with all its abbreviations and technical jargon, is too offputting. So, we've produced these first two simple patterns in an easy-to-follow pattern style which will allow the children to knit their own sweaters and, at the same time, familiarise themselves with some of the technicalities of a knitting pattern. Once they've knitted these patterns, children should be ready to attempt some of the other simple patterns in this book which are written in the normal pattern style. We have included a striped and plain version of these simple starter patterns and have varied the neckline slightly. We recommend that children start with the plain version and then have a go at the striped version.

BACK & FRONT ALIKE

Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Needles at left and right of centre O to Holding Position.

See our chart on page 24 for an explanation of each of the needle positions.

Using colour 2, cast on.

Your Instruction Book will give you detailed instructions for casting on.

Push Needles to Upper Working Position. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 5, knit 7 rows. Tension Dial at 8, knit 1 row. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 6. Continue in stripes of 4 rows colour 1, 4 rows col 2 throughout. Knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Mark both edges with waste yarn for armhole position.

Putting a waste yarn marker in at each side of your knitting at this stage will show you where the sleeves should be

For Knitmaster 9mm Chunky Machines.

Sizes:

To fit 61 (66) (71) (76) centimetres/24 (26) (28) (30) inch chest.

The figures in brackets represent the larger sizes. You should take your instructions from the same bracket throughout the pattern. For instance, if you are knitting size 28" chest which is in the 2nd bracket, always take your knitting instructions from the 2nd bracket.

Materials:

Knitmaster Chunky

Col 1 (Midnight) — 125 (145) (160) (175) grms

Col 2 (Serpentine) — 125 (145) (160) (175) grms

Tension:

Stockinet — 15 sts and 22 rows to 10 centimetres. Tension Dial at approximately 6.

Notice that we say the Tension Dial is at approximately 6. Each machine will knit at a slightly different tension — perhaps 5 or maybe 6. You must knit a tension swatch (or maybe as many as 3 or 4) to find which tension dial setting will give you the same stitches and rows to 10 centimetres as we have. It's very important that you have the same if your sweater is to come out to the correct size. Your instruction Book will tell you how to knit a tension square.

Pattern Note:

Striped stockinet. 4 rows col 1, 4 rows col 2.

Stripes are a nice easy way of introducing a 2nd colour or maybe even a 3rd or 4th colour if you like. Simply change the colour of yarn you are knitting with each time.

Knit to Row 86 (92) (100) (106). Cast off 10 (12) (13) (15) stitches at beginning of the next row, knit 1 row.

Your Instruction Book shows you in detail how to cast off.

Cast off 10 (12) (13) (15) stitches at beginning of the next row, knit 1 row. 30 (30) (32) (32) Needles remain in Working Position. Mark both ends with waste yarn. Knit to Row 104 (110) (118) (124). Cast off.

SLEEVES

Push 13 (13) (14) (14) Needles at left and right of centre O to Holding Position. Using colour 1, cast on. Push Needles to Upper Working Position. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 6. Continue in stripes of 4 rows col 1, 4 rows col 2 throughout, knit 22 rows. Row Counter 000. Increase 1 stitch at both ends of the next and every following 4th (4th) (5th) (5th) row until you have 50 (54) (56) (60) stitches.

Your Instruction Book shows you in detail how to increase a single stitch.

Knit straight until Row Counter shows 55 (63) (68) (77). Mark the centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams to marked points.

You can join the shoulders by sewing them with a normal back stitch or graft them as explained in your Instruction Book.

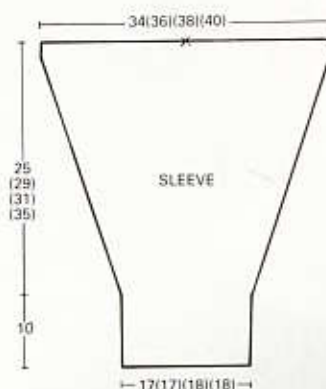
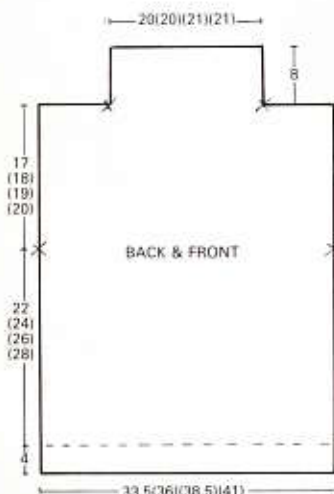
Set in sleeves between marked points.

Sew the top of the sleeves to the body pieces using a normal back stitch.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew side seams and sleeve seams together using a normal back stitch or blind stitch hem following the instructions given in your Instruction Book.

Allow cuff to roll back onto the outside and catch down into position. Turn hem to inside and catch down into position. Allow neck to roll to the outside. Give final light steam.



2 PLAIN SLASHED NECK SWEATER



For Knitmaster 9mm Chunky Machines.

Sizes:

To fit 61 (66) (71) (76) centimetres/24 (26) (28) (30) inch chest.

The figures in brackets represent the larger sizes. You should take your instructions from the same bracket throughout the pattern. For instance, if you are knitting size 28" chest which is in the 2nd bracket, always take your knitting instructions from the 2nd bracket.

Materials:

Knitmaster Chunky
Col 1 (Serpentine) — 250 (290) (320) (350) grms

Tension:

Stockinet — 15 sts and 22 rows to 10

centimetres. Tension Dial at approximately 6.

Notice that we say the Tension Dial is at approximately 6. Each machine will knit at a slightly different tension — perhaps 5- or maybe 6. You must knit a tension swatch (or maybe as many as 3 or 4) to find which tension dial setting will give you the same stitches and rows to 10 centimetres as we have. It's very important that you have the same if your sweater is to come out to the correct size. Your instruction Book will tell you how to knit a tension square.

Pattern Note:

Stockinet

BACK & FRONT ALIKE

Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Needles at left and right of centre O to Holding Position.

See our chart on page 24 for an explanation of each of the needle positions.

Using colour 1, cast on.

Your Instruction Book will give you detailed instructions for casting on.

Push Needles to Upper Working Position. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 5, knit 7 rows. Tension Dial at 8, knit 1 row. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 6. Knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Mark both edges with waste yarn for armhole position.

Putting a waste yarn marker in at each side of your knitting at this stage will show you where the sleeves should be positioned when you come to make up your sweater. You'll find details of how to do this in your Instruction Book.

Knit to Row 86 (92) (100) (106). Using waste yarn mark the 15th (15th) (16th) (16th) stitch at both sides of centre O. Tension Dial at 10, knit 1 row. Cast off.

SLEEVES

Push 13 (13) (14) (14) Needles at left and right of centre O to Holding Position. Using colour 1, cast on. Push Needles to Upper Working Position. Row Counter 000. Tension Dial at 6. Knit 22 rows. Row Counter 000. Increase 1 stitch at both ends of the next and every following 4th (4th) (5th) (5th) row until you have 50 (54) (56) (60) stitches.

Your Instruction Book shows you in detail how to increase a single stitch.

Knit straight until Row Counter shows 55 (63) (68) (77). Mark the centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams to marked points.

You can join the shoulders by sewing them with a normal back stitch or graft them as explained in your Instruction Book.

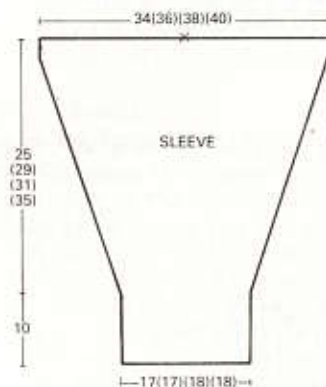
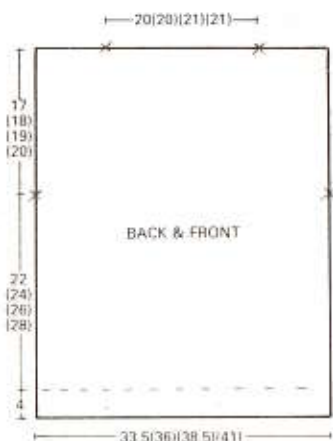
Set in sleeves between marked points.

Sew the top of the sleeves to the body pieces using a normal back stitch.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew side seams and sleeve seams together using a normal back stitch or blind stitch hem following the instructions given in your Instruction Book.

Allow cuff to roll back onto the outside and catch down into position. Turn hem to inside and catch down into position. Allow neck to roll to the outside. Give final light steam.

3 SADDLE SHOULDER CREW & V-NECK SWEATER & CARDIGAN



Here are 4 classic saddle shoulder designs which you can knit time and time again. Our photo shows the crew neck versions of the sweater and cardigan but the pattern also includes instructions for v-neck sweaters and cardigans. Knit them plain, as we have, or decorate them with any of the embroidery or Swiss Darned motifs which are included in this book.

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Cast off with waste yarn. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 50 (54) (58) (62) Ns altog. With carr at right pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasingly evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Mark both ends with waste yarn*. Knit 27 (29) (31) (33) rows.

Shape Shoulders

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 3rd (alt) (alt) (alt) row 3 (4) (4) (3) times in all. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 2 (2) (2) (4) rows. RC 84 (90) (98) (104). Mark the 8th st at left and right of centre O with waste yarn. Cast off rem 40 (42) (46) (48) sts.

CREW NECK SWEATER

FRONT

Knit as for Back to *. Knit 16 (18) (20) (20) rows.

Shape Shoulders

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 3rd (alt) (alt) (alt) row 3 (4) (4) (3) times in all. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 2 (2) (2) (4) rows. RC 73 (79) (87) (91). Mark the 6th st at left and right of centre O with waste yarn. Cast off rem 40 (42) (46) (48) sts.

For Knitmaster 9mm Chunky Machines.

Sizes:

To fit 61 (66) (71) (76) cms/24 (26) (28) (30) inch chest.

Materials:

Knitmaster Chunky. Colours shown Cloud Blue and Pink

Sweater

Col 1 - 260 (290) (320) (350) grms

Cardigan

Col 1 - 270 (300) (330) (360) grms

Crew Neck Cardigan - 8 (8) (9) (9) buttons.

V-Neck Cardigan - 6 (6) (7) (7) buttons.

Tensions:

Stockinet - 15 sts and 22 rows to 10 cms. TD at approx. 6 (MT)

Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib - 27 rows to 10 cms. TD at approx. MT-5

Pattern Note:

Stockinet

LEFT SLEEVE

Push 13 (13) (14) (14) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 26 (26) (28) (28) Ns altog. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT. Knit 2 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 4th row 8 (7) (7) (7) times in all, knit 3 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 5th row 5 (7) (8) (9) times in all. 52 (54) (58) (60) sts. Knit to Row 56 (64) (68) (78). Carr at right. Knit 1 row extra for Right Sleeve*. **Shape Saddle Shoulder

Cast off 11 (12) (14) (14) sts at beg of the next row and 18 (19) (21) (22) sts at beg of the next row. Cast off 2 sts at beg of the next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 2 rows. Knit 0 (0) (1) (1) row. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and foll alt row. 11 (11) (11) (12) sts. Knit 12 (14) (17) (19) rows. Carr at left.

Shape Neck Edge

Using a length of col 1, cast off 5 (5) (5) (6) sts at right of centre O. Hold Ns at right.

Knit Left Part as Follows:-

Knit 2 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next row, knit 1 row. Fasten off rem st. Take carr to right. Bring Ns back to WP.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at beg of the next and ev foll alt row 3 times in all, knit 1 row. Fasten off rem st**.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Knit as for Left Sleeve to * noting alteration in number of rows worked, then from **to** reading left for right and vice versa.

NECKBAND

Push 60 (60) (60) (63) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 15 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Set in sleeves and sew saddle shoulders into pos between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos and join centre back neck seam. Fold in half and catch down on the inside. Give final light steam.

V-NECK SWEATER

FRONT

Knit as for Back to*

Shape Neck

Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll 3rd (3rd) (3rd) (4th) row 6 (5) (3) (6) times in all.

2nd Size Only

Knit 3 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next row.

3rd Size Only

Knit 3 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll 4th row 3 times in all.

All Sizes

Knit 0 (1) (1) (1) row.

Shape Shoulder

Dec 1 st at right edge on the next row, knit 1 row.

1st Size Only

Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next row. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next row, knit 2 rows.

2nd & 3rd Sizes

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next row, knit 1 row.

4th Size Only

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next 2 rows.

All Sizes

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next row. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next 2 rows. Mark neck edge with waste yarn.

Cast off rem 12 (13) (15) (16) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part but read left for right.

LEFT SLEEVE

Knit as for Left Sleeve of Crew Neck Sweater to*.

**Shape Saddle Shoulder

Cast off 11 (12) (14) (15) sts at beg of the next row and 18 (19) (21) (22) sts at beg of the next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 2 rows. Knit 0 (0) (1) (1) row. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and foll alt row. 11 sts. Knit 12 (14) (17) (19) rows. Carr at left.

Shape Neck Edge

Using a length of col 1, cast off 5 sts at right of centre O. Hold Ns at right.

Knit Left Part as Follows:-

Knit 2 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next row, knit 1 row. Fasten off rem st. Take carr to right. Bring Ns back to WP.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts at beg of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at beg of the next row. Fasten off rem st**

RIGHT SLEEVE

Knit as for Left Sleeve to * noting alteration in number of rows worked then from **to** reading left for right and vice versa.

NECKBAND

Push 78 (81) (84) (87) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 9 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Set in sleeves and sew saddle shoulders into pos between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos overlapping at centre front. Give final light steam.

CREW NECK CARDIGAN

RIGHT FRONT

Push 22 (24) (26) (27) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Cast off with waste yarn. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns to WP. With carr at right pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Mark right edge with waste yarn*. Knit 16 (18) (20) (20) rows.

Shape Shoulder

Dec 1 st at right edge on the next and ev foll 3rd (alt) (alt) (alt) row 3 (4) (4) (3) times in all. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next 2 (2) (2) (4) rows. RC 73 (79) (87) (91). Mark the 6th st from left edge with waste yarn. Cast off rem 20 (21) (23) (24) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Knit as for Right Front but read left for right and vice versa.

SLEEVES

Knit as for sleeves on Crew Neck Sweater

NECKBAND

Knit as for Neckband on Crew Neck Sweater.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

Push 59 (63) (68) (71) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 5 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Make 8 (8) (9) (9) evenly spaced buttonholes over 1 N. Knit 4 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

BUTTON BAND

Knit as for Buttonhole Band but omit buttonholes.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Set in sleeves and sew saddle shoulders into pos between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos. Fold in half and catch down on the inside. Backstitch front bands into pos. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes. Give final light steam.

V-NECK CARDIGAN

RIGHT FRONT

Knit as for Right Front of Crew Neck Cardigan to*.

Shape Front Edge

Dec 1 st at left edge on the next and ev foll 3rd (3rd) (3rd) (4th) row 6 (5) (3) (6) times in all.

2nd Size Only

Knit 3 rows. Dec 1 st at left edge on the next row.

3rd Size Only

Knit 3 rows. Dec 1 st at left edge on the next and ev foll 4th row 3 times in all.

All Sizes

Knit 0 (1) (1) (1) row.

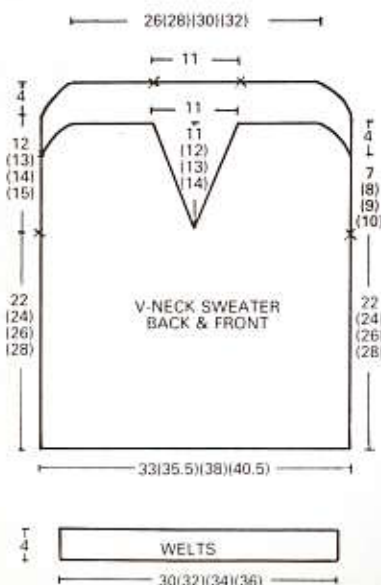
Shape Shoulder

Dec 1 st at right edge on the next row, knit 1 row.

1st Size Only

Dec 1 st at left edge on the next row.

Dec 1 st at right edge on the next row, knit 2 rows.



2nd & 3rd Sizes Only

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next row, knit 1 row.

4th Size Only

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at right edge on the next 2 rows.

All Sizes

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next row. Dec 1 st at right edge of the next 2 rows. Mark neck edge with waste yarn. Cast off rem 12 (13) (15) (16) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Knit as for Right Front but read left for right and vice versa.

SLEEVES

Knit as for Sleeves on V-Neck Sweater.

BACK NECKBAND

Push 24 Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC000. MT-5, knit 9 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

BUTTONHOLE BAND

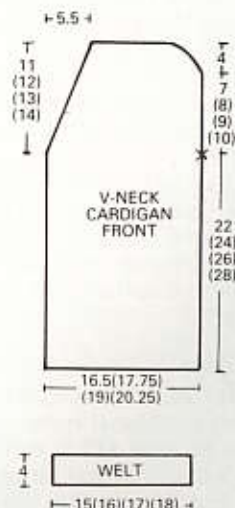
Push 68 (72) (77) (81) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 5 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Make 6 (6) (7) (7) evenly spaced buttonholes over 1 N on 39 (42) (45) (48) Ns at right. Knit 4 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

BUTTON BAND

Knit as for Buttonhole Band but omit buttonholes.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Set in sleeves and sew saddle shoulders into pos between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos. Backstitch front bands into pos and join seams. Sew on buttons to correspond with buttonholes. Give final light steam.

4 INTARSIA JACKET



For Knitmaster 9mm Chunky Machines with Intarsia Carriage.

Sizes:

To fit 61 (66) (71) (76) cms/24 (26) (28) (30) inch chest.

Materials:

Knitmaster Chunky.
 Col 1 (Serpentine) – 90 (100) (110) (120) grms
 Col 2 (Geranium) – 90 (100) (110) (120) grms
 Col 3 (Bluebell) – 90 (100) (110) (120) grms
 Col 4 (Black) – 130 (140) (150) (160) grms

Col 5 (White) – 90 (100) (110) (120) grms

1.20 metres 115 cms wide printed cotton for lining; 16 (17) (18) (19) inch chunky open ended zip fastener; elastic to fit cuffs.

Tensions:

Intarsia – 15 sts and 22 rows to 10 cms. TD at approx. 6 (MT)
 Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib – 27 rows to 10 cms. TD at approx. MT-5

Pattern Note:

Intarsia – see chart.

This brightly coloured zip-up jacket has been knitted in intarsia and we have lined it with an equally colourful cotton fabric to give it a more professional finish. However, you can just as easily knit a plain, unlined version if you like or a plain version with a colourful lining would be quite effective.

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5. Knit 16 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 27 (29) (31) (33) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 54 (58) (62) (66) Ns altog. With carr at right, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in Intarsia. Knit 46 (50) (54) (58) rows. Mark both ends with waste yarn. Knit 38 (40) (42) (44) rows. RC 84 (90) (96) (102). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Note pos in pattern. Using a length of appropriate col, cast off centre 16 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Cast off 3 sts beg next row. Cast off rem 16 (18) (20) (22) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Keeping pattern correct, knit left part as for right part.

RIGHT FRONT

Push 22 (24) (26) (28) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 16 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 27 (29) (31) (33) Ns right of centre O to WP. With carr at right, pick up sts from below waste yarn and

place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in Intarsia. Knit 46 (50) (54) (58) rows. Mark right edge with waste yarn. Knit 25 (27) (27) (29) rows. RC 71 (77) (81) (87). Carr at left.

Shape Neck

Cast off 4 sts at beg of the next row, knit 1 row. Cast off 3 sts at beg of the next row, knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts beg of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st beg of the next and foll alt row, knit 6 (6) (8) (8) rows. Cast off rem 16 (18) (20) (22) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Knit as for Right Front but reverse the shapings by reading left for right and vice versa.

SLEEVES

Push 25 (25) (27) (27) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 8 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 14 (14) (15) (15) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 28 (28) (30) (30) Ns altog. Pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in Intarsia. Knit 4 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 4th row 13 (15) (15) (17) times in all. 54 (58) (60) (64) sts. Knit to Row 57 (65) (70) (79). Mark centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

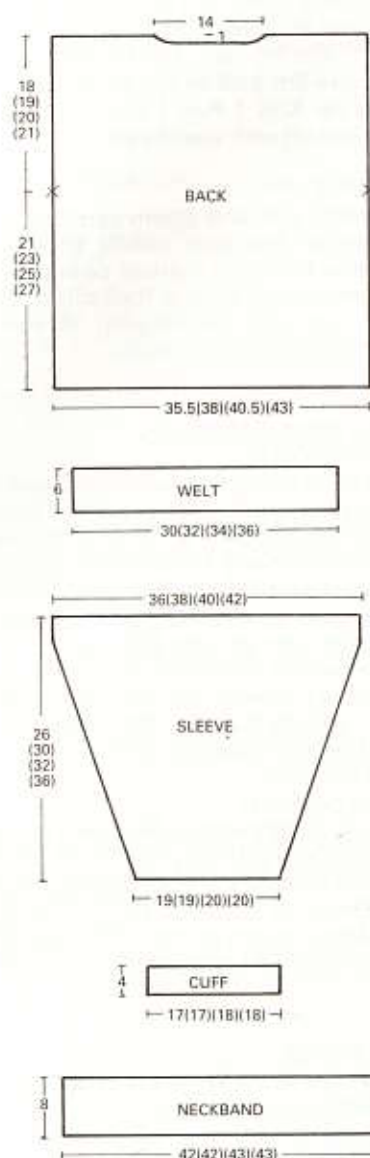
NECKBAND

Push 63 (63) (65) (65) Ns to WP. Using col 4, cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 16 rows. Knit 2 rows col 2, 2 rows col 1. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT col 1. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos, fold in half and catch down on the inside. Line jacket if desired using knitted pieces as a pattern plus 1" seam

allowance and an additional 5cm at centre back and sleeves to form a pleat for movement. Make a small casing at cuff edge and thread elastic through casing. Sew on zip fastener.

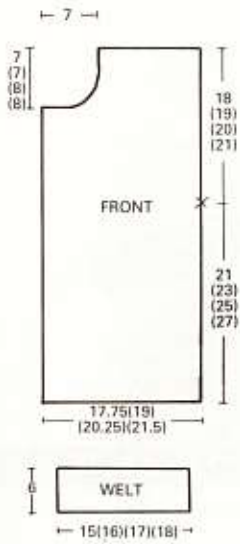

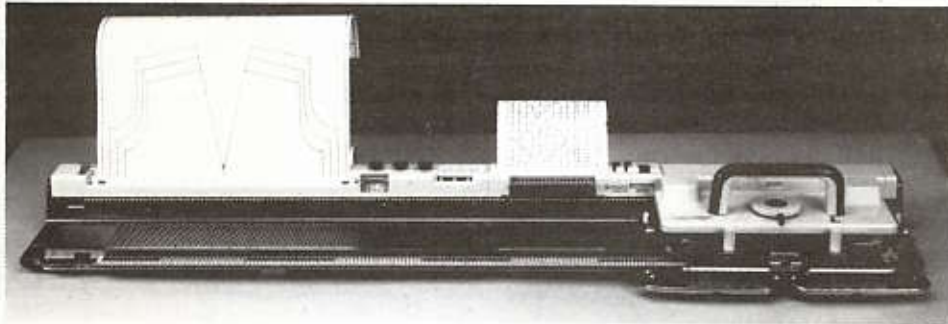

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5 SET IN SLEEVE CREW AND V-NECK SWEATER AND CARDIGAN



This pattern includes instructions for 4 classic set in sleeve chunky designs. We've photographed the crew neck sweater and cardigan but we also give instructions for v-neck sweaters and cardigans. These 4 designs will be ideal for schoolwear or, by introducing stripes of colour or perhaps Swiss Darning a motif, you'll find they're equally suited to children's fashion.

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Cast off with waste yarn. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 50 (54) (58) (62) Ns altog. With carr at right pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasingly evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1**, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Carr at right.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 2 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 4th row 3 (4) (4) (5) times in all. 40 (42) (46) (48) sts*. Knit to Row 82 (88) (96) (102). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck & Shoulder

Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 14 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Cast off 5 (6) (7) (7) sts beg next row, 3 sts beg next row. Cast off rem 5 (5) (6) (7) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

SLEEVES

Push 26 (26) (27) (27) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT. Knit 2 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 5th row 10 (12) (13) (15) times in all. 46 (50) (53) (57) sts. Knit to

For Knitmaster 9mm Chunky Machines.

To fit 61 (66) (71) (76) cms/24 (26) (28) (30) inch chest.

Sweater

Shape Top

Cast off 3 sts beg next 2 (4) (4) (4) rows.

1st Size Only

Cast off 2 sts beg next 4 rows.

All Sizes

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll alt row 3 (4) (5) (5) times in all, knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts beg next 2 (4) (4) (6) rows, 3 sts beg next 2 rows and 4 sts beg next 2 rows. Cast off rem 8 (8) (9) (9) sts.

CREW NECK SWEATER

FRONT

Knit as for back to*. Knit to Row 70 (76) (84) (88). Carr at right.

Shape Neck

Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 10 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll 3rd row 3 times in all. Knit to Row 82 (88) (96) (102).

Carr at right.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 5 (6) (7) (7) sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Cast off rem 5 (5) (6) (7) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part but read left for right.

NECKBAND

Push 60 (60) (60) (63) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 15 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos and join centre back neck seam. Fold in half and catch down on the inside. Give final light steam.

V-NECK SWEATER

FRONT

Knit as for Back to**. Knit 46 (50) (56) (60) rows. Carr at right.

Shape Neck

Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Dec 1 st at left edge on the next row, knit 1 row. RC 48 (52) (58) (62). Carr at right.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 2 sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll 4th row 9 times in all, AT THE SAME TIME dec 1 st at armhole edge on the next and ev foll 4th row 3 (4) (4) (5) times in all. Knit to Row 82 (88) (96) (102). Carr at right.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 5 (6) (7) (7) sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Cast off rem 5 (5) (6) (7) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part but read left for right and vice versa.

NECKBAND

Push 78 (81) (84) (87) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 9 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch neckband into pos overlapping at centre front. Neaten front edge. Give final light steam.

CREW NECK CARDIGAN

RIGHT FRONT

Push 22 (24) (26) (27) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Cast off with

6 ARAN CREW NECK SWEATER & CARDIGAN



These beautiful Aran style sweaters show just how far machine knitting has come in recent years. Even if you don't intend knitting these designs just yet, knit a sample piece of the fabric following the larger chart, just to familiarise yourself with the techniques involved. You may even like to use this fabric to knit a beautiful Aran style sweater for yourself.

BACK

Push 23 (25) (26) (28) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 46 (50) (52) (56) Ns altog. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-6, knit 14 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 26 (28) (30) (32) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 52 (56) (60) (64) Ns altog. Carr at right. Pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns in WP increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in pattern. Knit 52 (58) (62) (68) rows. Mark both ends with waste yarn*. Knit 38 (42) (44) (46) rows. RC 90 (100) (106) (114). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Note pos in pattern. Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 16 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Cast off 3 sts beg next row. Cast off rem 15 (17) (19) (21) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Keeping pattern correct, knit left part as for right part.

SLEEVES

Push 13 (13) (14) (14) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 26 (26) (28) (28) Ns altog. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-6, knit 14 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 16 (16) (17) (17) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 32 (32) (34) (34) Ns altog. Pick up

FRONT

Knit as for Back to*. Knit 26 (30) (32) (32) rows. RC 78 (88) (94) (100). Carr at right. Shape Neck

Note pos in pattern. Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 10 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 4 (4) (4) (6) rows. Cast off rem 15 (17) (19) (21) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Keeping pattern correct, knit left part as for right part.

CARDIGAN

RIGHT FRONT

Push 23 (25) (26) (28) Ns at right of centre O to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-6, knit 14 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 26 (28) (30) (32) Ns at right of centre O to WP. Carr at right. Pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns in WP increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in pattern. Knit 52 (58) (62) (68) rows. Mark right edge with waste yarn. Knit 25 (29) (31) (31) rows. RC 77 (87) (93) (99). Carr at left.

Shape Neck

Cast off 5 sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st beg next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 4 (4) (4) (6) rows. Cast off rem 15 (17) (19) (21) sts.

LEFT FRONT

Knit as for Right Front but read left for right and vice versa throughout.

SWEATER & CARDIGAN

NECKBAND

Push 62 (62) (62) (65) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-6, knit 15 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. MT, knit 1 row. Cast off with waste yarn.

CARDIGAN

BUTTONHOLE BAND

Push 62 (67) (72) (75) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-6, knit 5 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Make 9 (9) (10) (10) evenly spaced buttonholes over 1 N. Knit 4 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. MT, knit 1 row. Cast off with waste yarn. Knit button band as for buttonhole band but omit buttonholes.

SWEATER

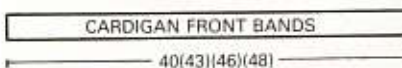
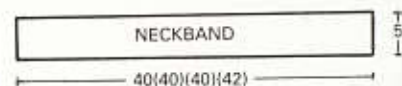

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn, knit 8 rows and release from machine. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 50 (54) (58) (62) Ns altog. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Carr at right**.

Shape Raglan Armholes

Cast off 3 sts beg next 2 rows***.

1st & 2nd Sizes Only

Dec 1 st both ends of next and foll alt row, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 5 rows 6 more times.

2nd Size Only

Dec 1 st both ends next and foll alt row.

3rd Size Only

Dec 1 st both ends next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 9 rows from *to* 3 more times. Dec 1 st both ends of next and foll alt row.

4th Size Only

Dec 1 st both ends of next and ev foll alt row 20 times in all.

All Sizes

16 sts. Knit 1 (0) (1) (3) rows. RC 86 (92) (100) (106). Cast off.

LEFT SLEEVE

Push 13 (13) (14) (14) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 26 (26) (28) (28) Ns altog. Cast on as given in additional

notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT. Knit 2 (2) (2) (4) rows. Inc 1 st both ends of the next and ev foll 4th row 15 (17) (18) (19) times in all. 56 (60) (64) (66) sts. Knit to Row 60 (68) (72) (82). (Knit 1 row extra for Right Sleeve Only). Carr at right.

Shape Raglan Top

Cast off 3 sts beg next 2 rows. Dec 1 st both ends of next 20 (22) (24) (25) rows, knit 0 (0) (0) (1) row. 10 sts. Carr at right. Cast off 8 sts beg next row, knit 1 row. Cast off rem 2 sts.

RIGHT SLEEVE

Knit as for Left Sleeve but note alteration in number of rows worked and read left for right.

CREW NECK SWEATER

FRONT

Knit as for Back to ***.

1st & 2nd Sizes Only

Dec 1 st both ends of next and foll alt row, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 5 rows 4 more times.

2nd Size Only

Dec 1 st both ends of next row, knit 1 row.

3rd Size Only

Dec 1 st both ends of next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 9 rows from *to* twice more. Dec 1 st both ends of next row, knit 1 row.

Dec 1 st both ends of next and ev foll alt row 15 times in all.

Knit as for Back to**.

Shape Neck and Raglan Armhole Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:—

Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll 4th (4th) (4th) (5th) row 8 times in all, AT THE SAME TIME cast off 3 sts beg next row, knit 1 row.

1st & 2nd Sizes Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and foll alt row, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 5 rows 5 more times.

1st Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next row.

2nd Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and foll alt row.

3rd Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 9 rows from *to* twice more. Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 1 row.

4th Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and ev foll alt row 19 times in all.

All Sizes

RC 81 (87) (95) (101). Cast off rem 1 (2) (2) (1) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

Using waste yarn knit 8 rows and release from machine. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at right of centre O to WP. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Carr at right*.

Shape Raglan Armhole

Cast off 3 sts beg next row, knit 1 row.

1st & 2nd Sizes Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and foll alt row, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 5 rows 4 more times.

2nd Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next row, knit 1 row.

3rd Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and ev foll alt row 4 times in all, knit 2 rows. Rept the last 9 rows from *to* twice more. Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next row, knit 1 row.

4th Size Only

Dec 1 st at raglan edge on the next and ev foll alt row 15 times in all.

All Sizes

12 (13) (13) (13) sts. RC 75 (81) (89) (93). Carr at left.

Shape Neck

1st Size Only

Additional Notes

Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib

Push required number of needles to Working Position.

Insert transfer tool into the end loop of the first row of main knitting.

Lift that loop and put into the end needle. Bring the alternate needles forward to Working Position.

Knit the number of rows stated in the pattern.

Drop the 3rd and every following alternate stitch back to the waste yarn.

Using the latch tool, reform the dropped stitches in the following way.

Insert the latch tool under the loop of the first row of main knitting. Ignoring the next 3 bars, catch the yarn of the 5th row in the hook of the latch tool.

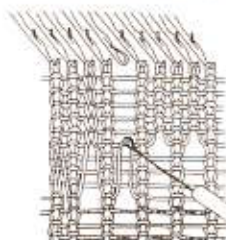
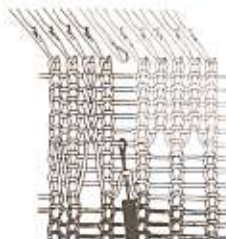
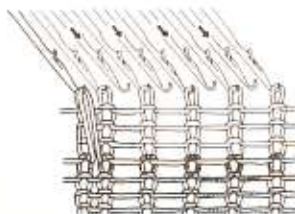
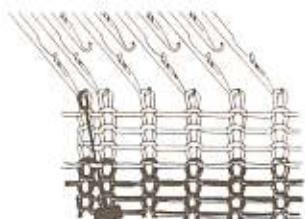
Pull the tool towards you until the first loop slips over the hook to form a new stitch.

Continue reforming stitches in this way until all the bars above have been knitted.

Replace the stitch onto the needle.

Repeat this procedure on alternate stitches until the rib is complete.

Missing 3 bars at the bottom each time gives this rib a nice firm edge.

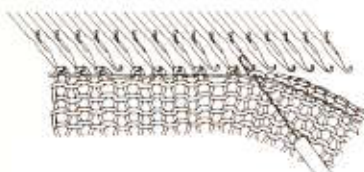


Increasing evenly across a row

1. Push up additional needles required for increase to WP and place the stitches of the last row of main knitting onto the needles in WP omitting a needle at appropriate intervals.

Remove the waste knitting.

2. Pick up the stitches of the previous row, next to the empty needle, and place them onto the empty needles.

8 DROP SHOULDER CREW AND V-NECK SWEATER AND CARDIGAN



Our photo shows two versions of these drop shoulder designs — the v-neck cardigan and the crew neck sweater. However you'll also find instructions for v-neck sweaters and crew neck cardigans in this pattern. Use these lovely simple shapes as a basis for some of your own designs. Introduce a small motif using garter stitch or perhaps sew on a ready made badge motif.

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Cast off with waste yarn. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 50 (54) (58) (62) Ns altog. With carr at right pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Mark both ends with waste yarn*. Knit 36 (38) (40) (42) rows. RC 84 (90) (98) (104). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 14 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:—

Knit 1 row. Cast off 3 sts beg next row. Cast off rem 15 (17) (19) (21) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

SLEEVES

Push 26 (26) (27) (27) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT. Knit 2 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 4th row 7 (7) (7) (11) times in all, knit 3 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 5th row 5 (7) (8) (6) times in all. 50 (54) (57) (61) sts. Knit to Row 55 (63) (68) (77). Mark centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

9 NAUTICAL SWEATERS



These simple but effective designs show two alternative methods of introducing a motif. Intarsia is the most obvious method of introducing a motif and is always effective. However, garter stitch is also a possible method and produces a lovely, subtle textured motif. Why not experiment with this technique using other motifs you have in your collection?

INTARSIA SWEATER

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib but knit first 4 rows after waste yarn in col 2. RC 000. MT-5. Using col 1, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Cast off with waste yarn. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 50 (54) (58) (62) Ns altog. 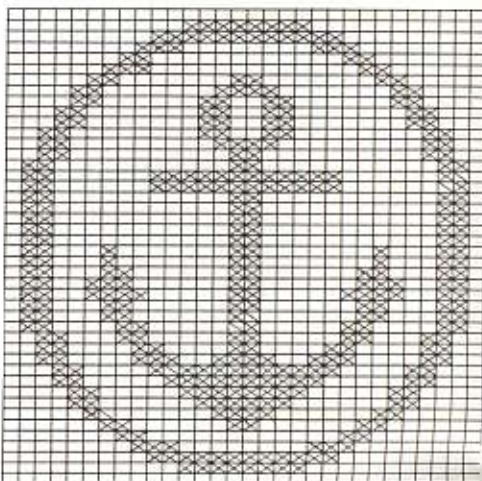
waste yarn in col 2. RC 000. MT-5. Using col 1, knit 18 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch front bands into pos lapping buttonhole band over button band. Neaten lower edge. Backstitch collar into pos starting and finishing at centre of front bands. Sew on buttons.

Knit as for Intarsia Anchor Sweater but reverse colours and follow chart in garter stitch.

Push 46 (50) (52) (56) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-6, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 26 (28) (30) (32) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 52 (56) (60) (64) Ns altog. With carr at right, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. Mark between the 12th & 13th st each side of centre O with waste yarn. RC 000. MT. Using col 1 continue in cable pattern working centre of cables over marked point. Knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Carr at right.

Shape Armholes

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll alt row 5 times in all. 42 (46) (50) (54) sts. Knit 27 (29) (31) (33) rows. RC 84 (90) (98) (104). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 16 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:—

Cast off 5 (6) (7) (8) sts beg of the next row and 3 sts beg of the next row. Cast off rem 5 (6) (7) (8) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

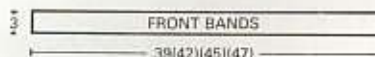
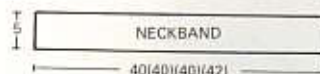

Shape Back Neck

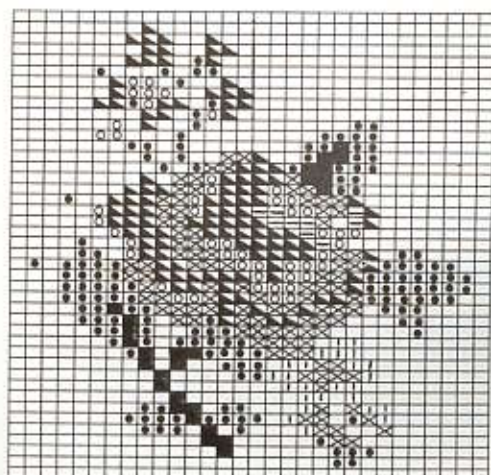
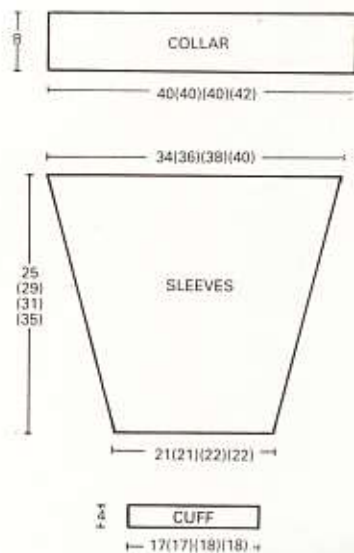
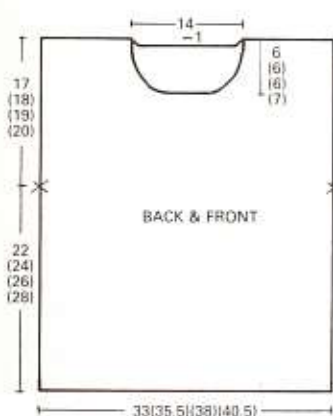

Swiss Darning and embroidery on knitwear is fashionable at the moment, not just for adults but for children too. And, of course it's actually quite easy using chunky yarn.

BACK

Push 45 (48) (51) (54) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 25 (27) (29) (31) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 50 (54) (58) (62) Ns altog. With carr at right, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, knit 48 (52) (58) (62) rows. Carr at right.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 3 sts at beg of the next 2 rows. 44 (48) (52) (56) sts. Knit 34 (36) (38) (40) rows. RC 84 (90) (98) (104). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 14 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:-

Knit 1 row. Cast off 3 sts beg next row. Cast off rem 12 (14) (16) (18) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

This heavily textured pattern has been created using garter stitch but could certainly be confused with an intricate hand knitted design! If you look at the garter stitch chart you will see that you could easily work out some of your own heavily textured garter stitch patterns. Why not try knitting one or two of your own ideas.

BACK

Push 48 (51) (54) (57) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5. Using col 1, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 29 (31) (33) (35) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. With carr at right, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in garter stitch pattern. Knit 50 (54) (60) (64) rows. Carr at right.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 5 sts beg of the next 2 rows. 48 (52) (56) (60) sts*. Knit 36 (38) (40) (42) rows. RC 88 (94) (102) (108). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Note pos in pattern. Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 18 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as follows:–

Knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts beg of the next row. Cast off rem 13 (15) (17) (19) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Keeping pattern correct, knit left part as for right part.

FRONT

Knit as for Back to*. Knit 24 (26) (28) (28) rows. RC 76 (82) (90) (94). carr at right.

Shape Neck

Note pos in pattern. Mark centre with waste yarn. Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 10 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:–

Knit 1 row. Cast off 2 sts at beg of the next row, knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll alt row 4

times in all, knit 4 (4) (4) (6) rows. Cast off rem 13 (15) (17) (19) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Keeping pattern correct, knit left part as for right part.

SLEEVES

Push 27 (27) (29) (29) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5. Using col 1, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 34 (34) (35) (35) Ns to WP. Carr at right. Pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Continue in garter stitch pattern. Knit 0 (4) (4) (4) rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 6th (5th) (5th) (5th) row 10 (12) (13) (15) times in all. 54 (58) (61) (65) sts. Knit 0 (4) (4) (3) rows. RC 55 (64) (69) (78). Mark both ends with waste

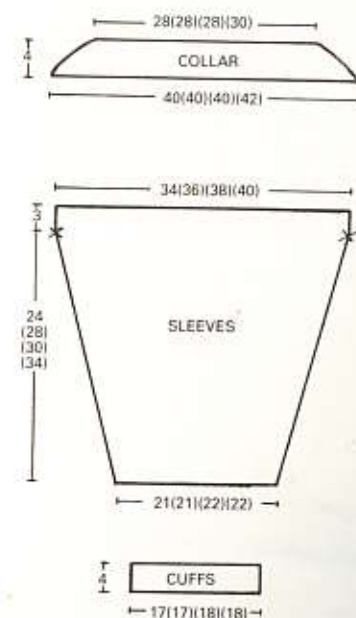
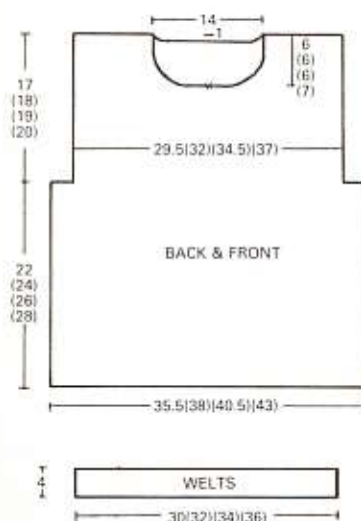
yarn. Knit 7 rows. Mark centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

NECKBAND

Push 64 (64) (64) (68) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5. Using col 1, knit 1 row. Always taking yarn round first inside N in HP, push 1 N at opposite end to carr to HP on the next 8 rows and 2 Ns on the next 2 rows. Break yarn. Using a transfer tool, bring Ns in HP back to WP. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves sewing rows above marker to cast off sts at armhole. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch collar into pos starting and finishing at centre front. Give final light steam.

For Knitmaster 9mm Chunky Machines.

Sizes:

To fit 61 (66) (71) (76) cms/24 (26) (28) (30) inch chest.

Materials:

Knitmaster Chunky.
Col 1 (Aran) – 320 (350) (380) (410) grms
Col 2 (Pale Blue) – small amount
Col 3 (Serpentine) – small amount
Col 4 (Bluebell) – small amount

Tensions:

Stockinet & Cables – 16.5 sts and 23 rows to 10 cms. TD at approx. 6 (MT)

Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib – 27 rows to 10 cms. TD at approx. MT-5

Pattern Note:

Follow chart for cable pattern.

Note:

When shaping collar, drop sts and pick up as for ribbing before pushing Ns to HP.

Cables are a lovely way of introducing texture into any design and are particularly effective knitted in chunky yarn. This design has been further embellished with bands of Swiss Darning which make this simple sweater look very exclusive indeed. In fact, just think what a sweater like this would cost to buy in the shops!

BACK

Push 50 (53) (56) (59) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5. Knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 28 (30) (32) (34) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 56 (60) (64) (68) Ns altog. With carr at right, pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, continue in cable pattern. Knit 50 (54) (60) (64) rows. Mark both ends with waste yarn*. Knit 38 (40) (42) (44) rows. RC 88 (94) (102) (108). Carr at right.

Shape Back Neck

Note pos in pattern. Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 18 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:—

Knit 1 row. Cast off 3 sts beg next row. Cast off rem 16 (18) (20) (22) sts. Take carr to left. Bring Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

FRONT

Knit as for Back to*. Knit 12 (14) (14) (16) rows. RC 62 (68) (74) (80). Carr at right.

Shape Neck

Using a length of col 1, cast off centre 16 sts. Hold Ns at left.

Knit Right Part as Follows:—

Knit 6 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on the next and ev foll 6th row 4 times in all, knit 3 (3) (5) (5) rows. Cast off rem 16 (18) (20) (22) sts. Take carr to left. Bring

Ns back to WP. Knit left part as for right part.

SLEEVES

Push 28 (28) (30) (30) Ns to WP. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 10 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. Using waste yarn knit several rows and release from machine. Push 17 (17) (18) (18) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 34 (34) (36) (36) Ns altog. Pick up sts from below waste yarn and place onto Ns increasing evenly. RC 000. MT. Using col 1, continue in cable pattern. Knit 1 row. Inc 1 st at both ends of the next and ev foll 5th row 11 (13) (13) (15) times in all. 56 (60) (62) (66) sts. Knit to Row 57 (66) (71) (80). Mark centre with waste yarn. Cast off.

COLLAR

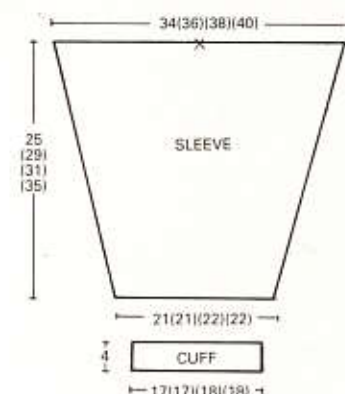
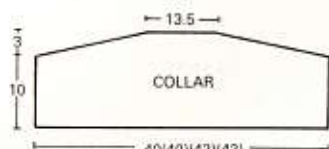
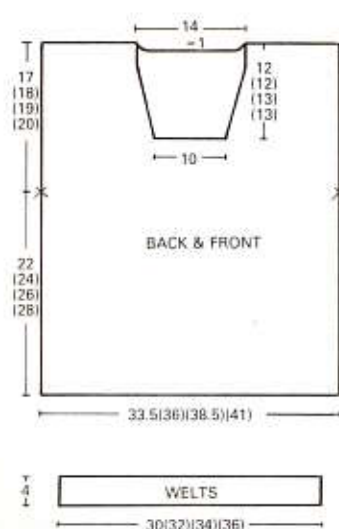
Push 33 (33) (35) (35) Ns at left and right of centre O to WP. 66 (66) (70) (70) Ns altog. Cast on as given in additional notes for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib. RC 000. MT-5, knit 27 rows. Drop the 3rd and ev foll alt st and pick up as for Knit 1 Purl 1 Rib.

Shape Top

Push 6 Ns at opposite end to carr to HP on the next 4 rows and 5 (5) (6) (6) Ns on the next 4 rows. 22 Ns rem in WP. Using a latch tool bring Ns in HP back to WP. Knit 1 row MT. Cast off with waste yarn.

TO MAKE UP

Pin out to size and steam carefully. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves between marked points. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch collar into pos overlapping at front. Swiss darn following chart. Give final light steam.

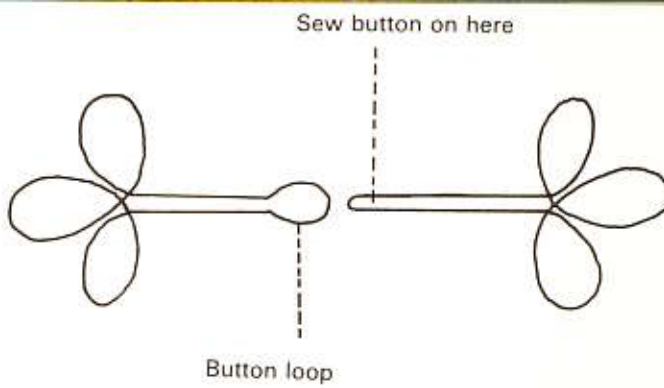

FROGGING CLASPS

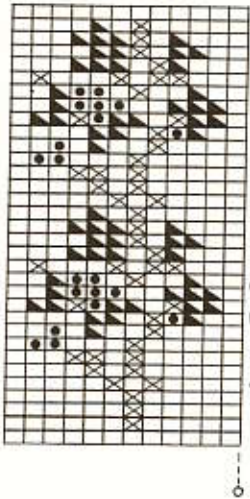
