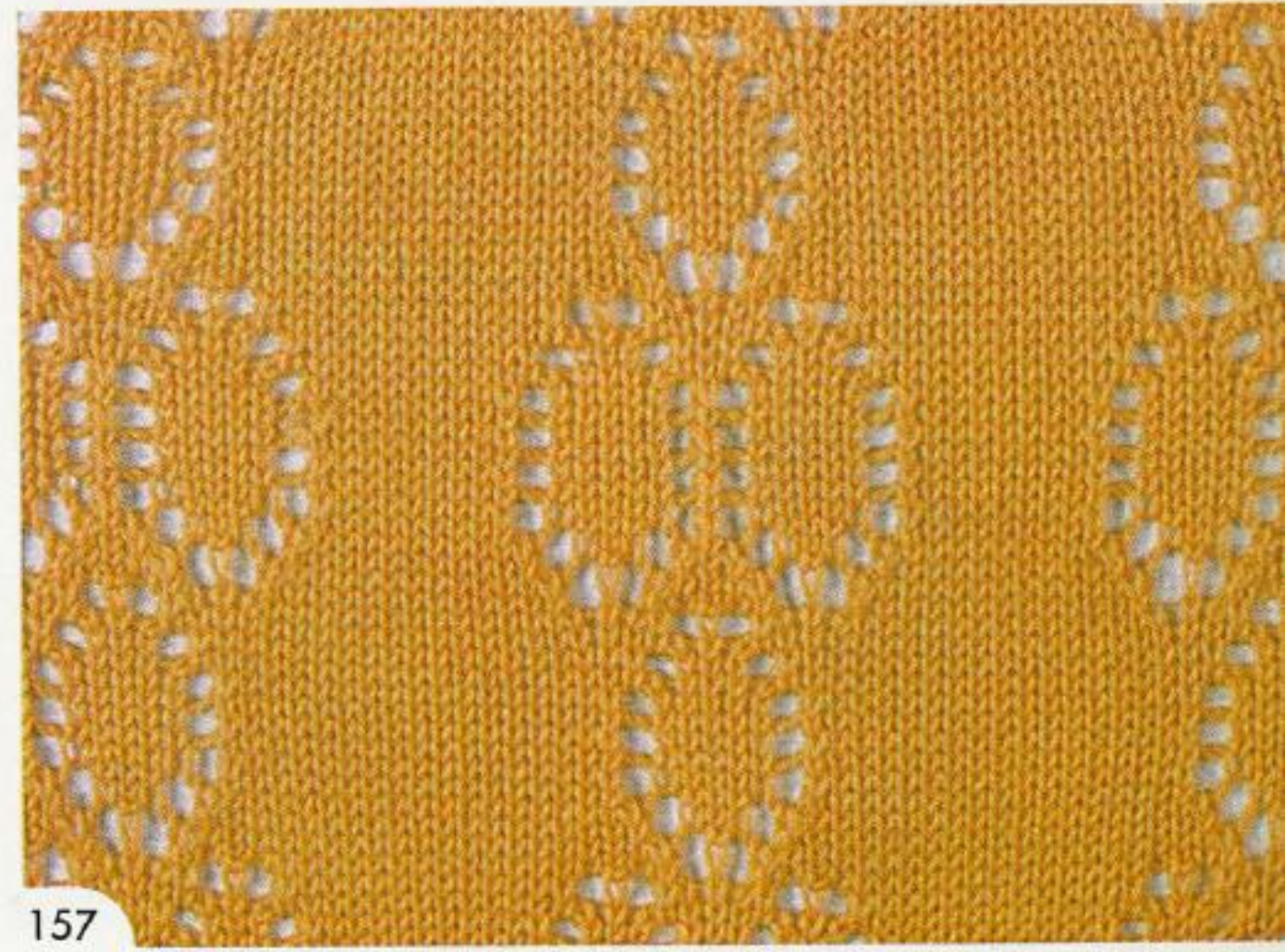
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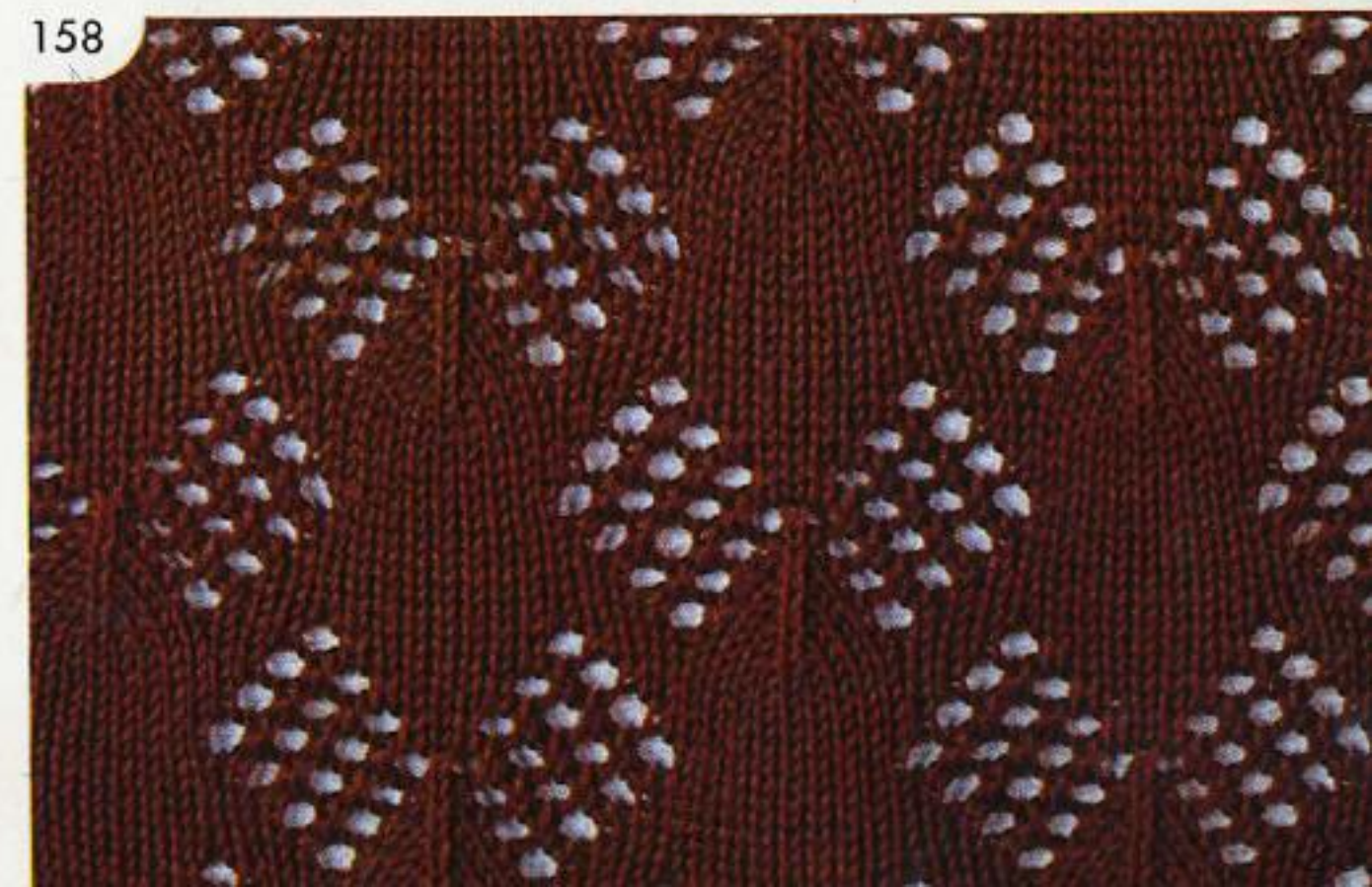
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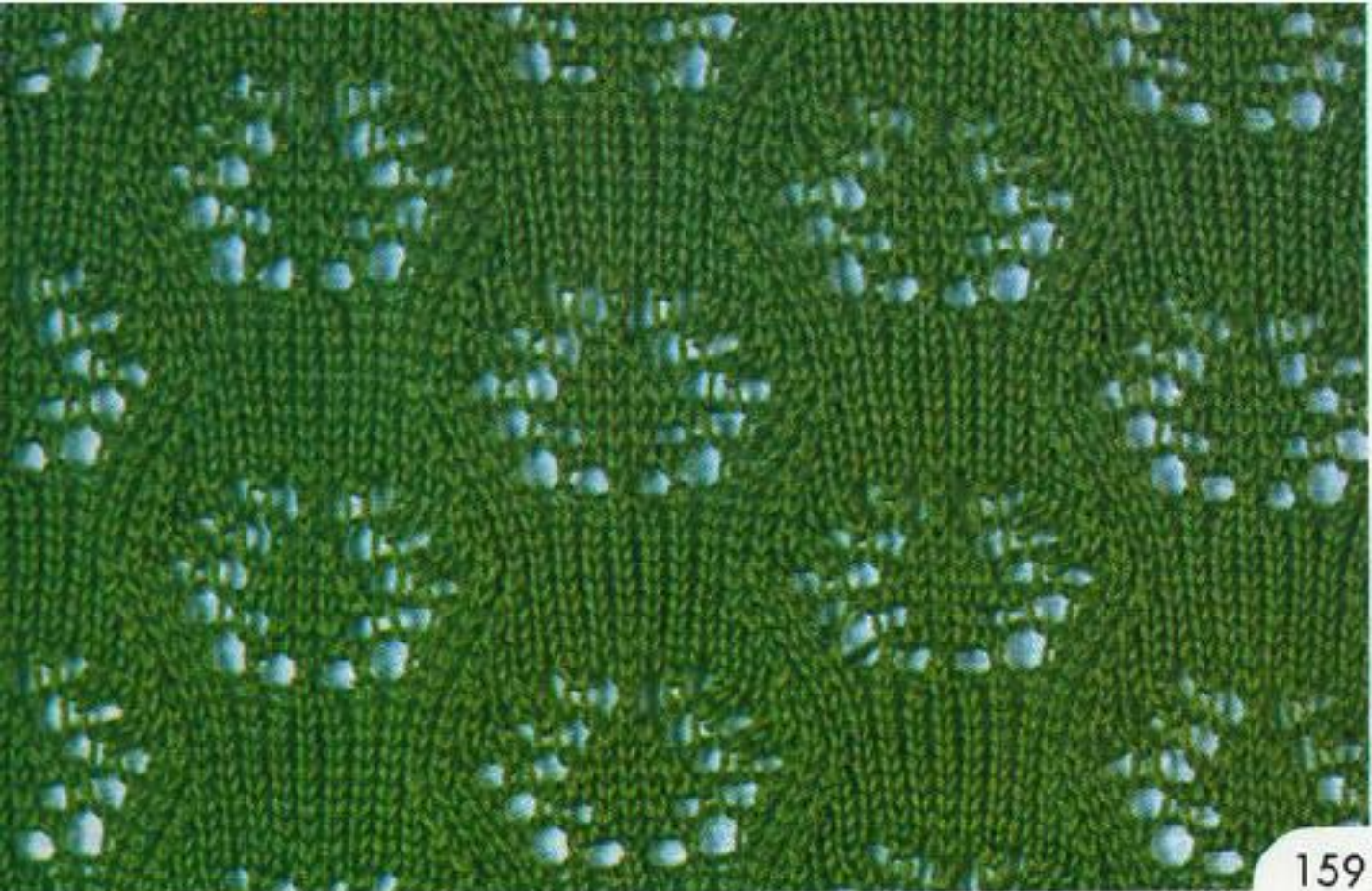
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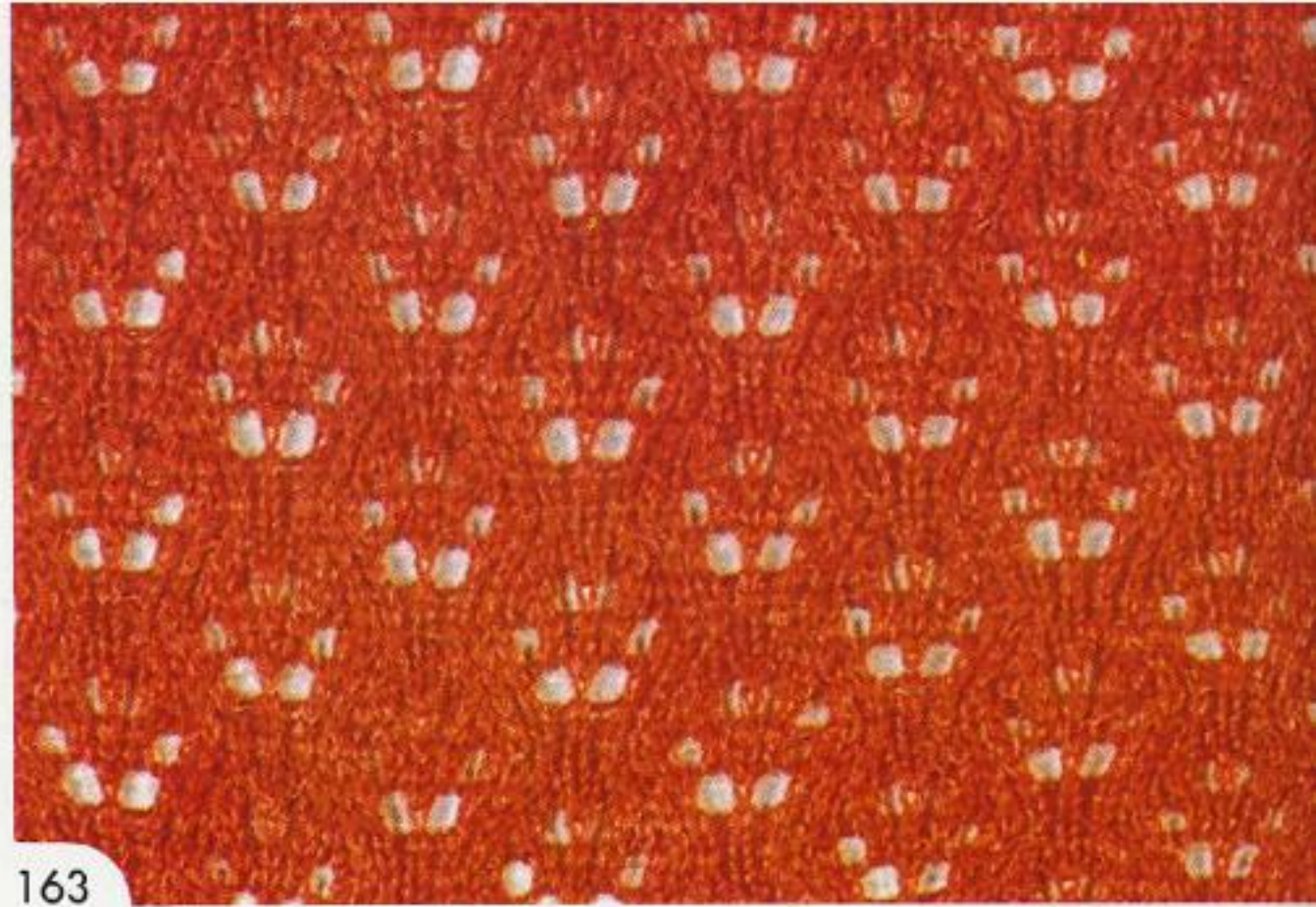
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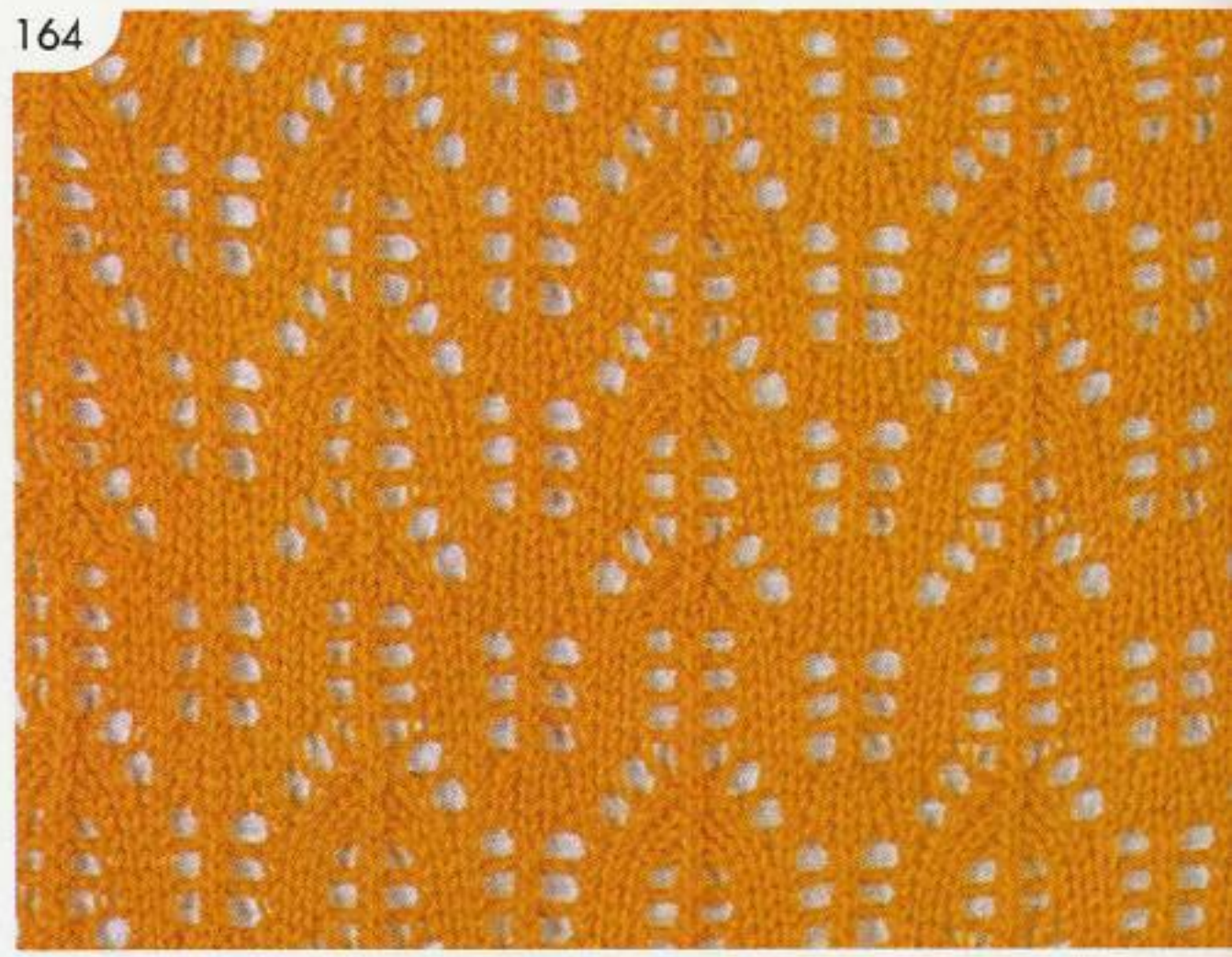
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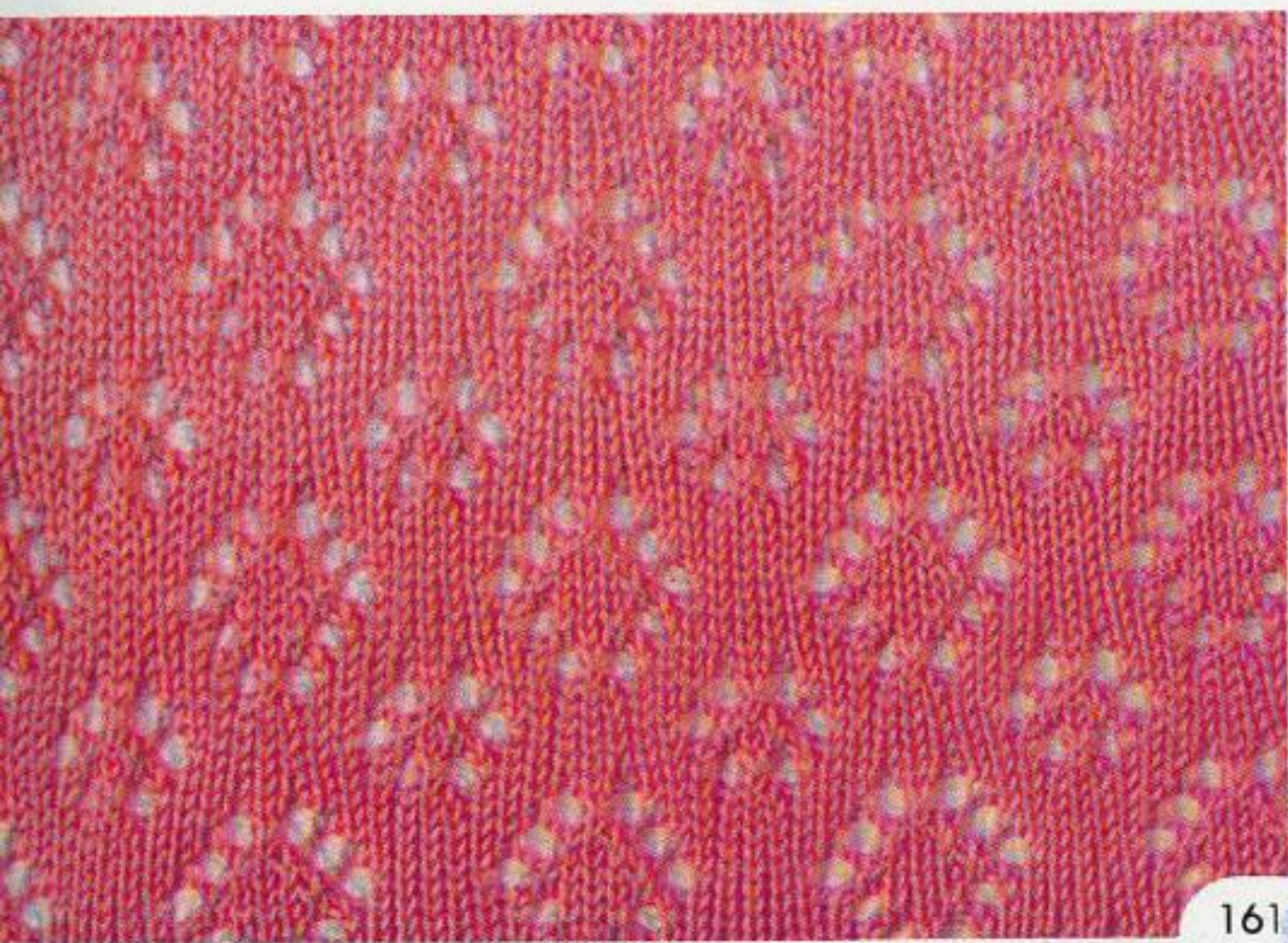
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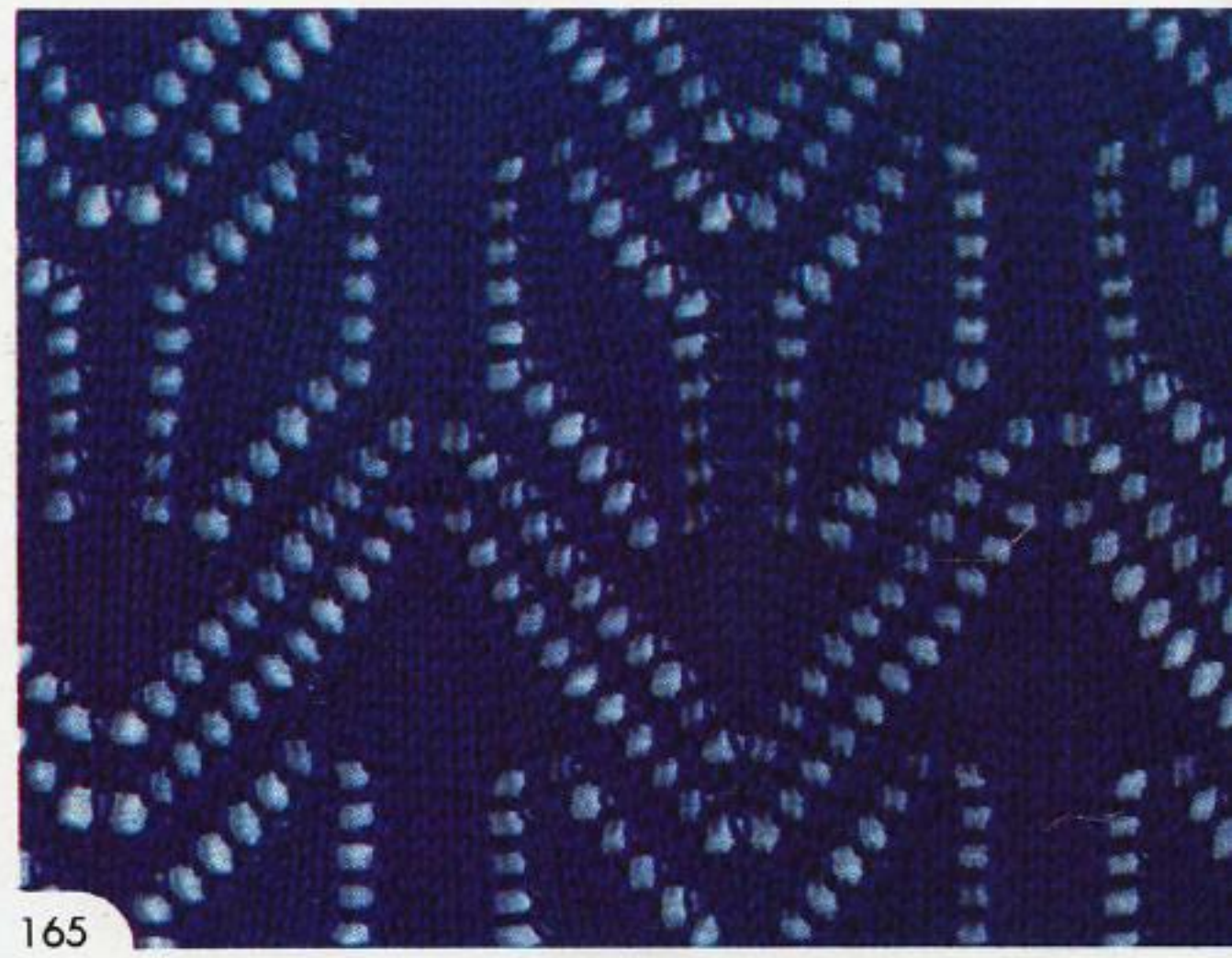
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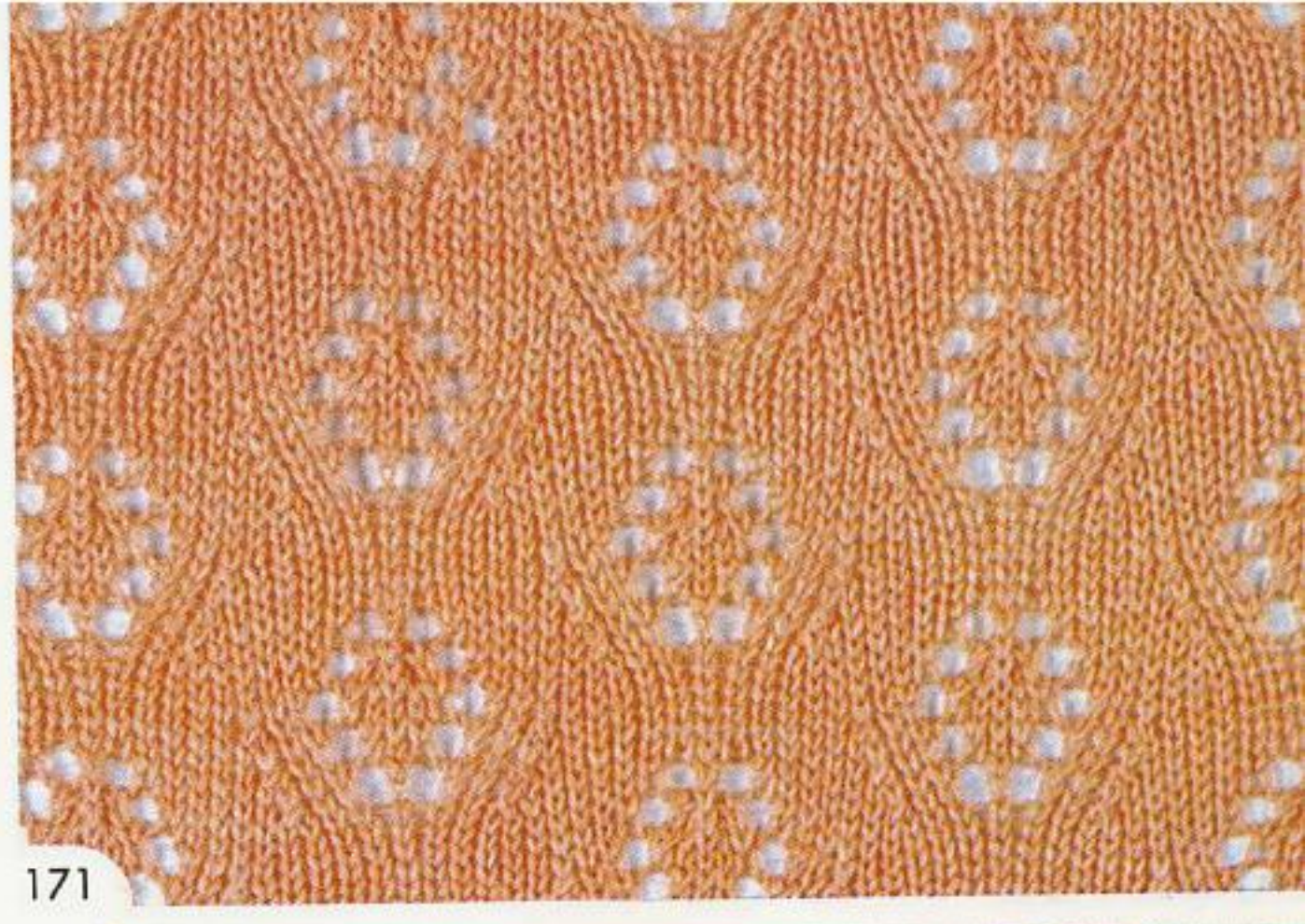
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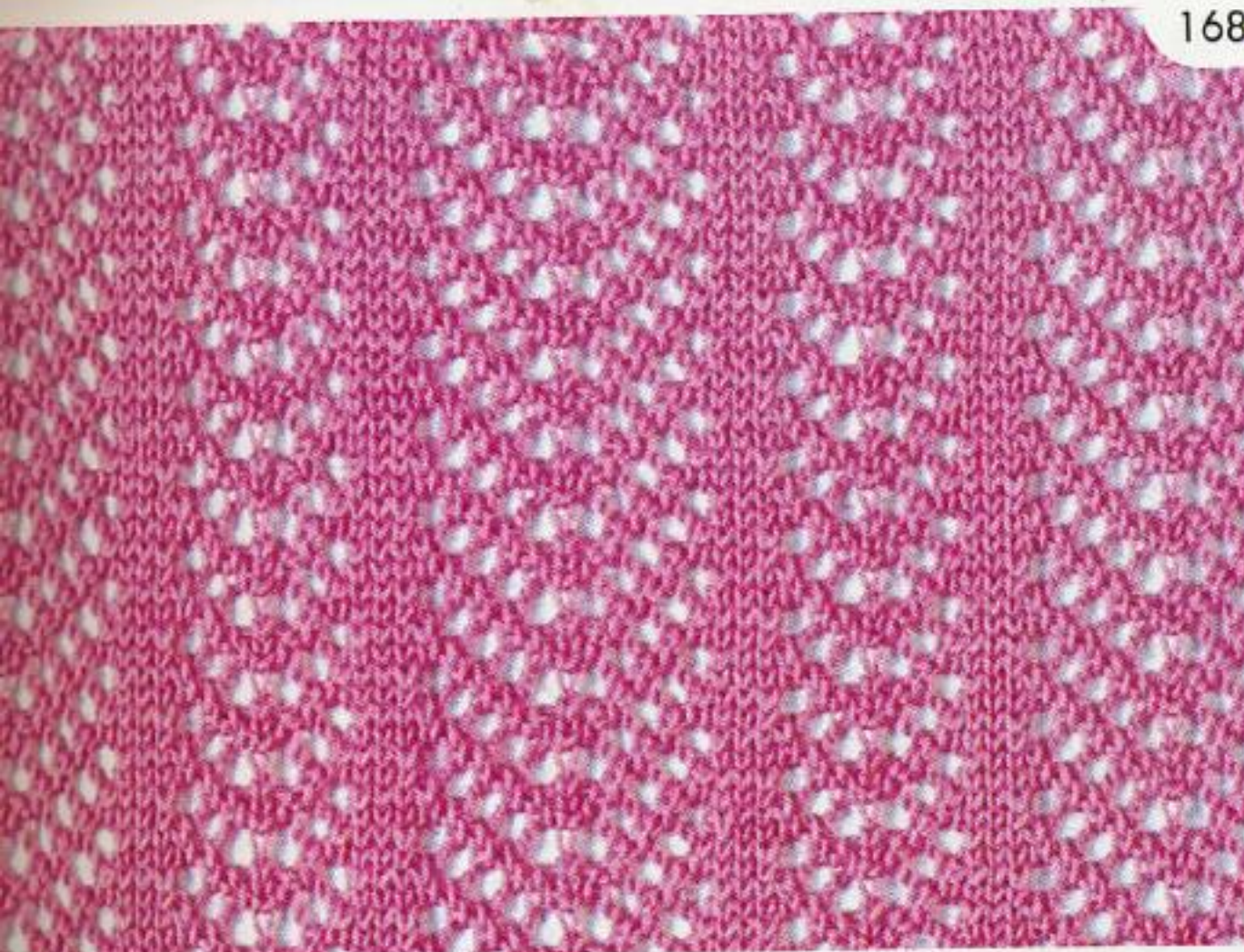
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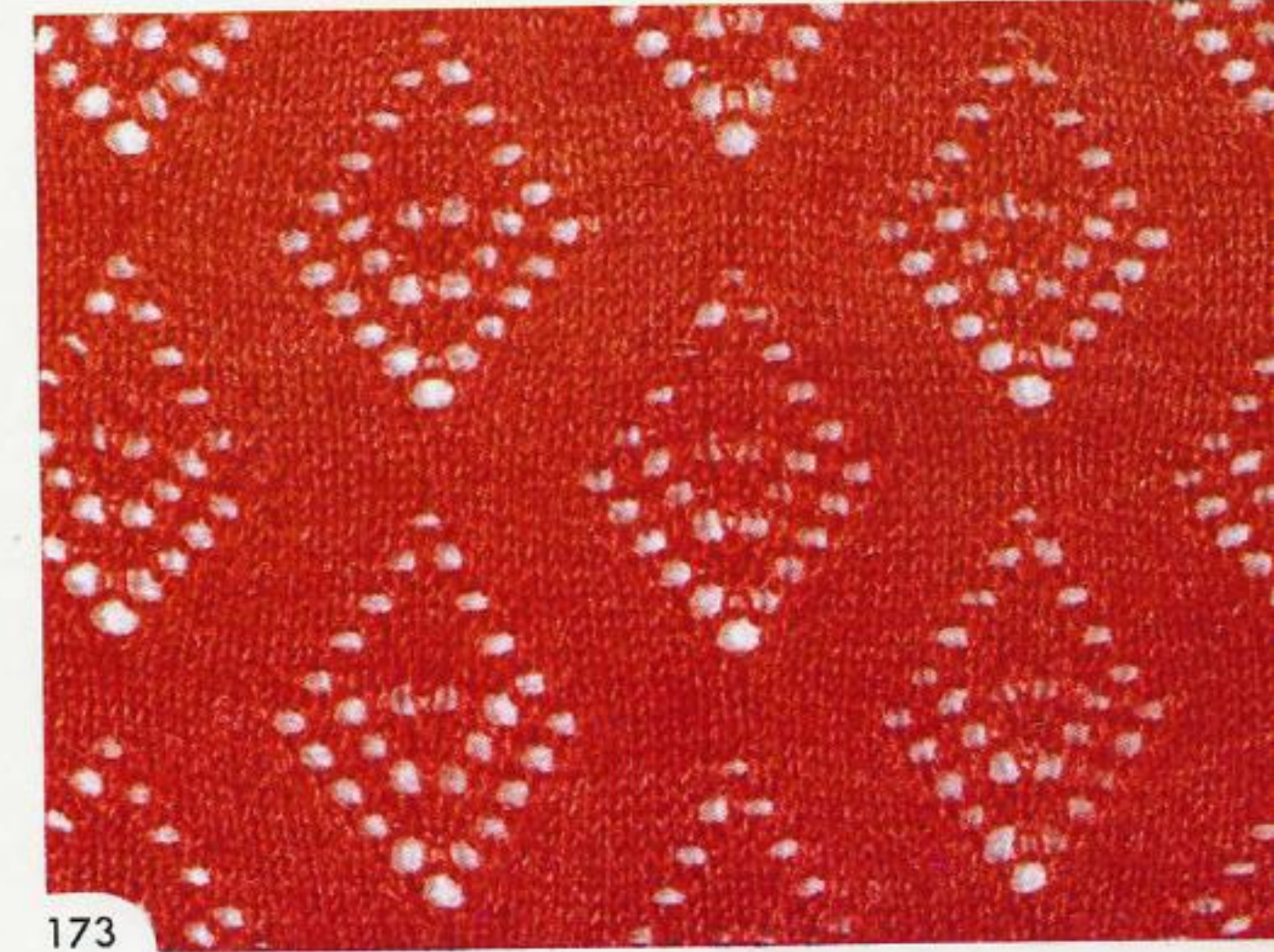
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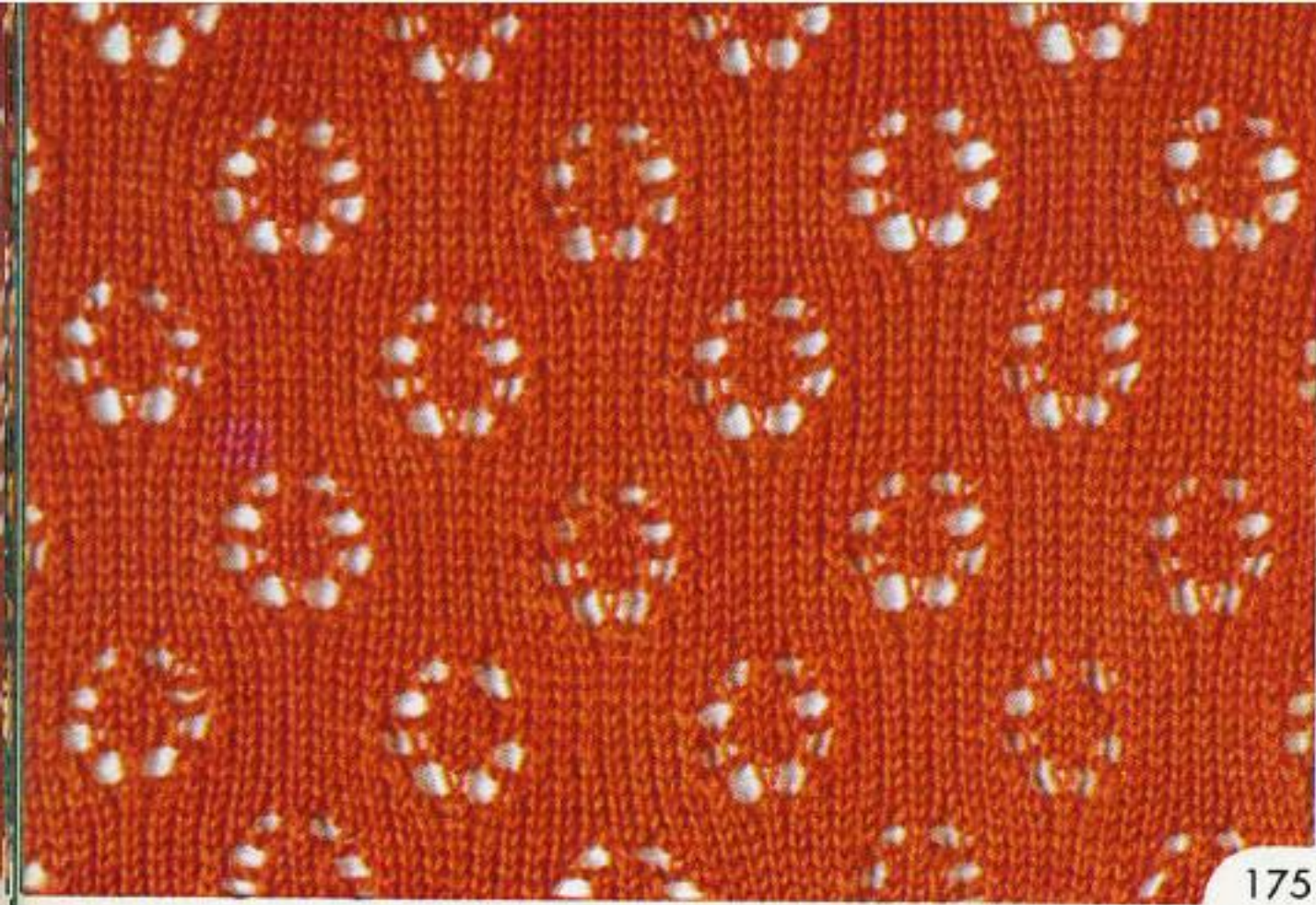
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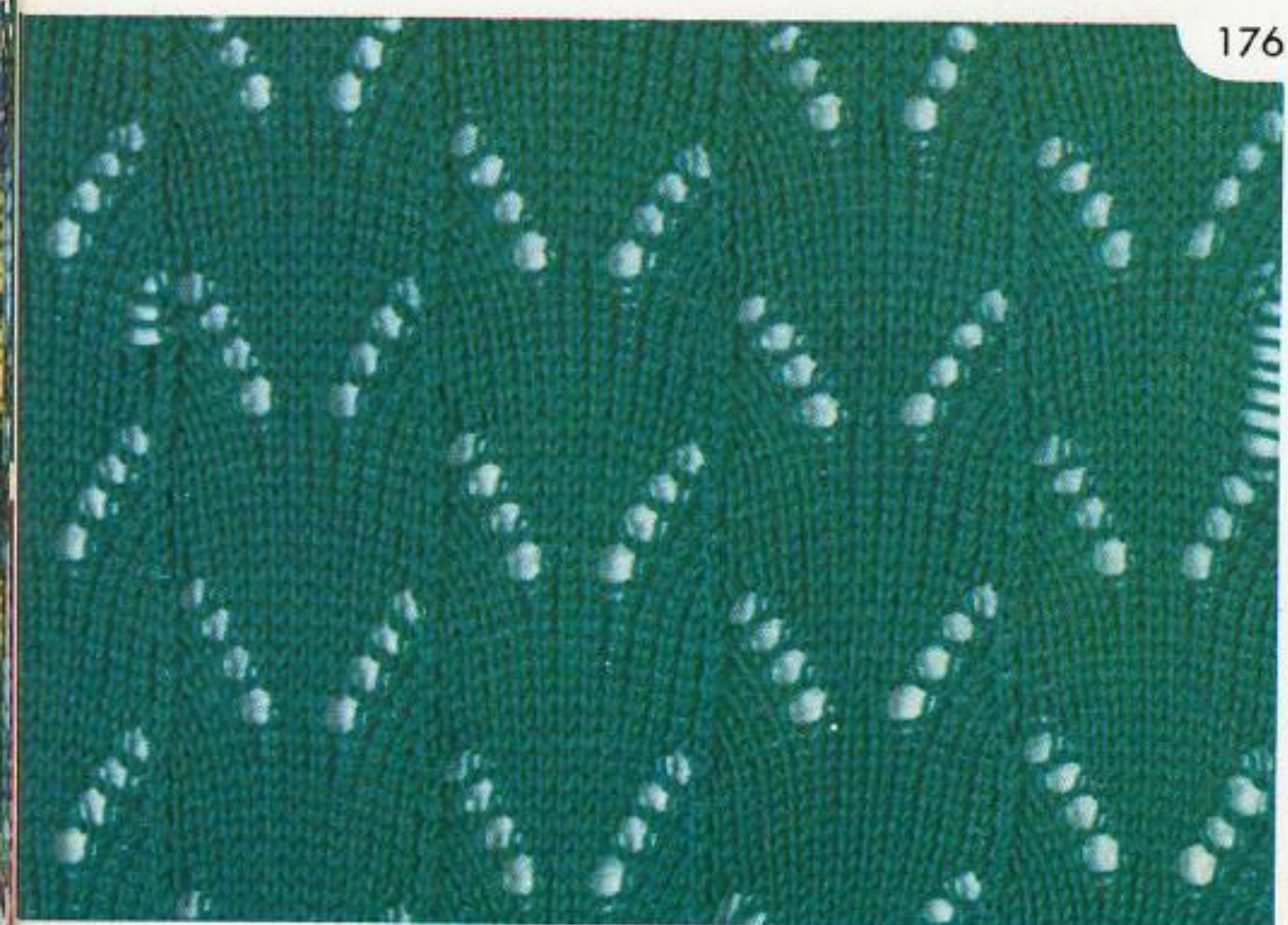
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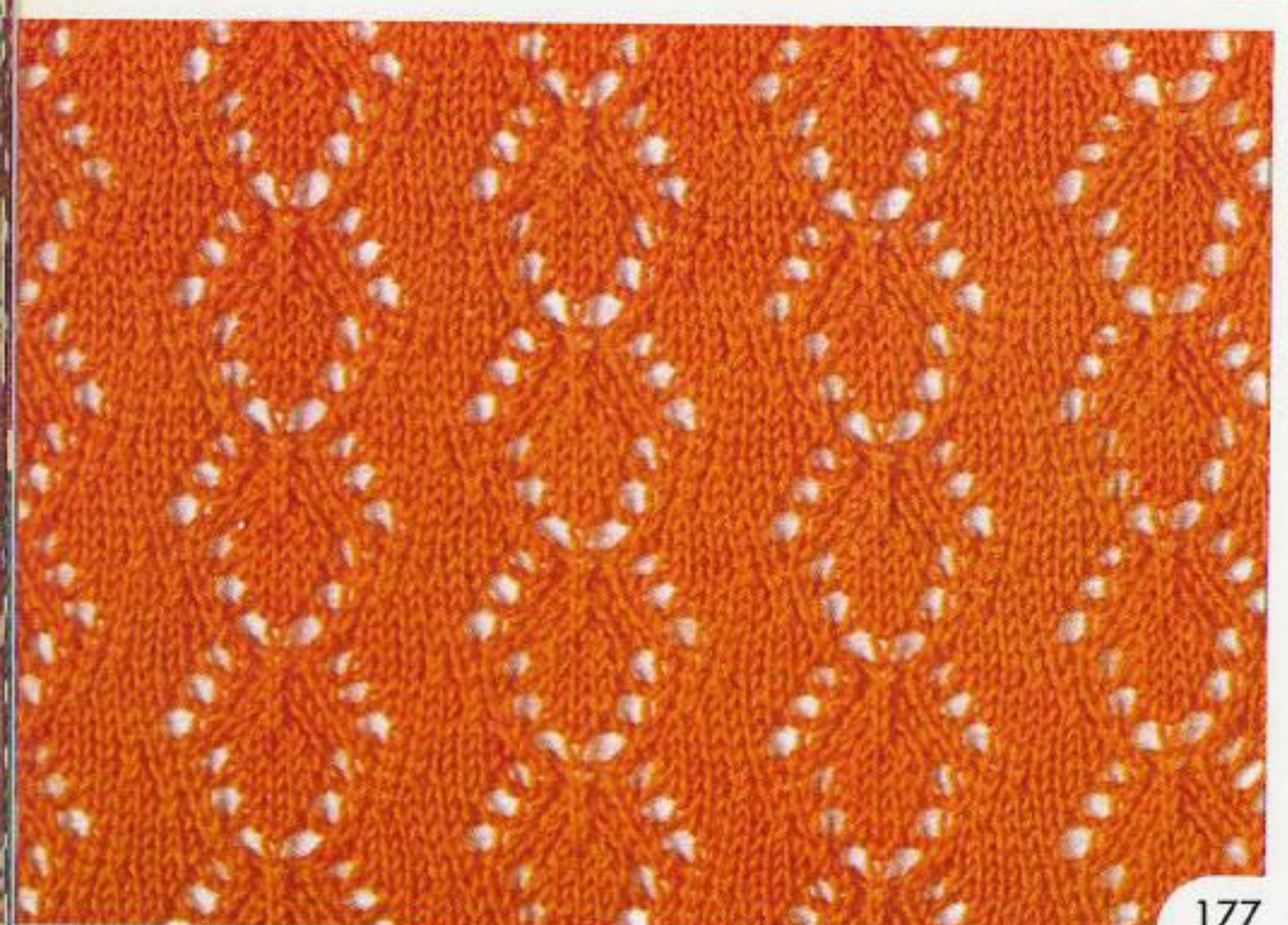
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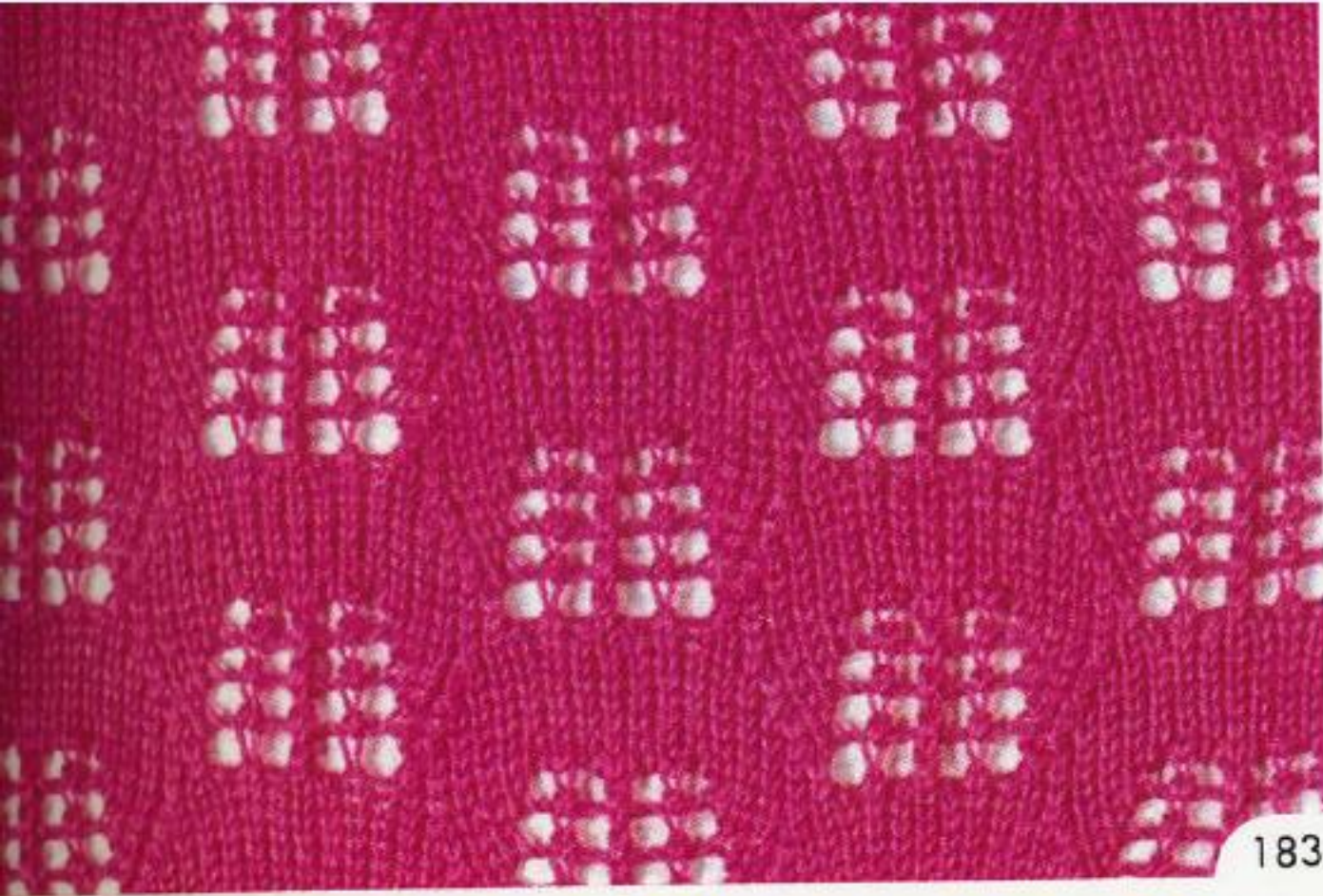
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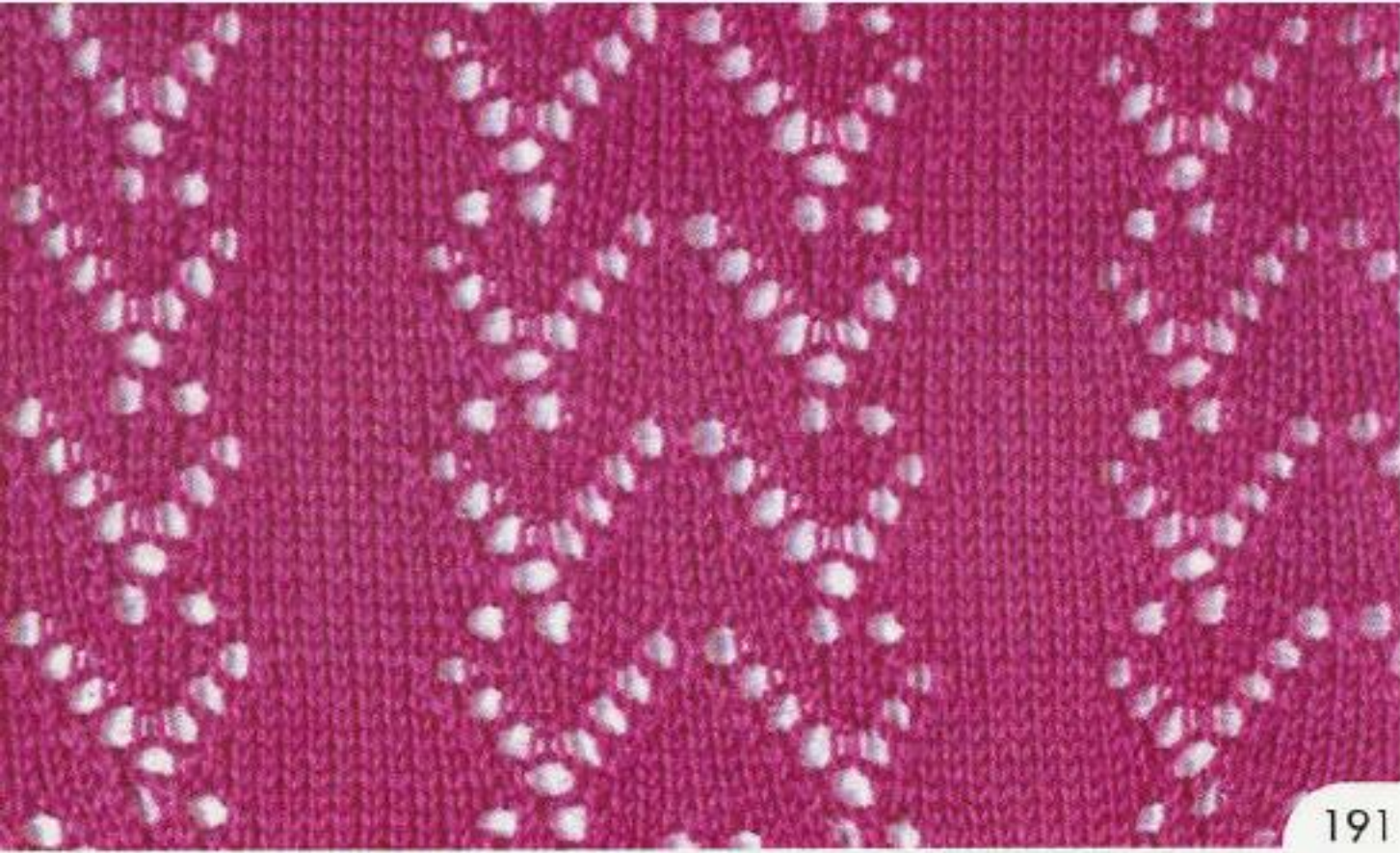
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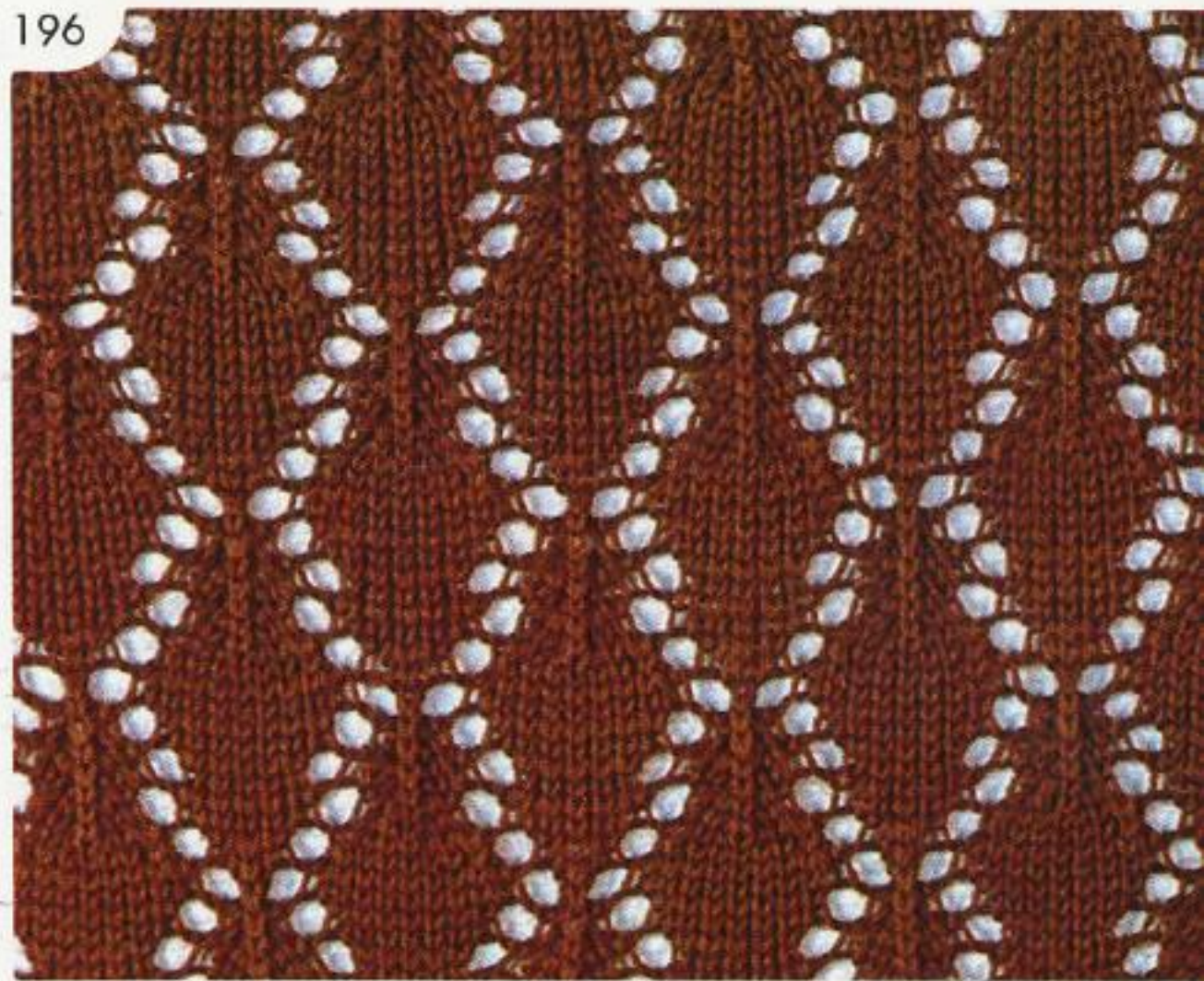
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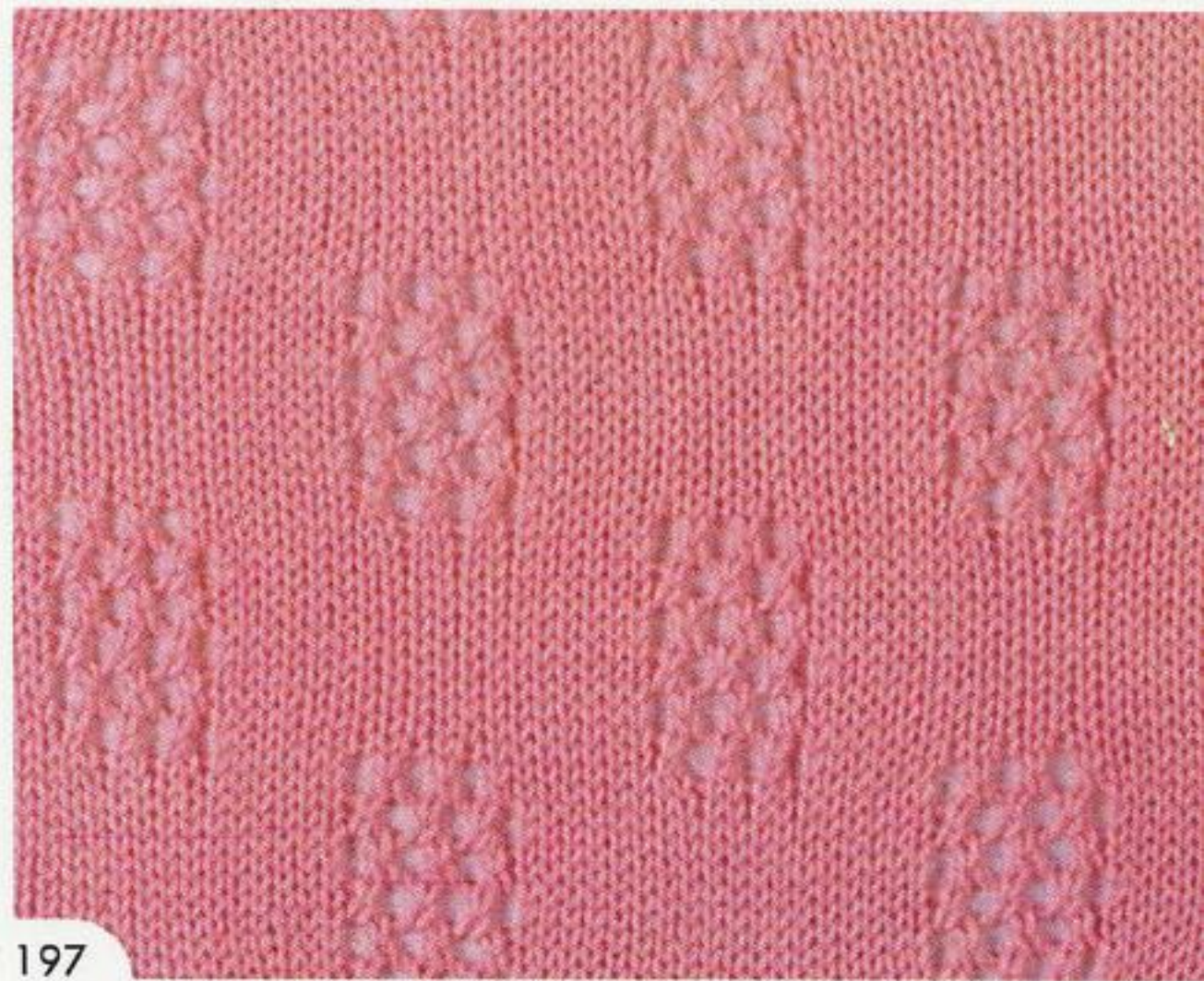
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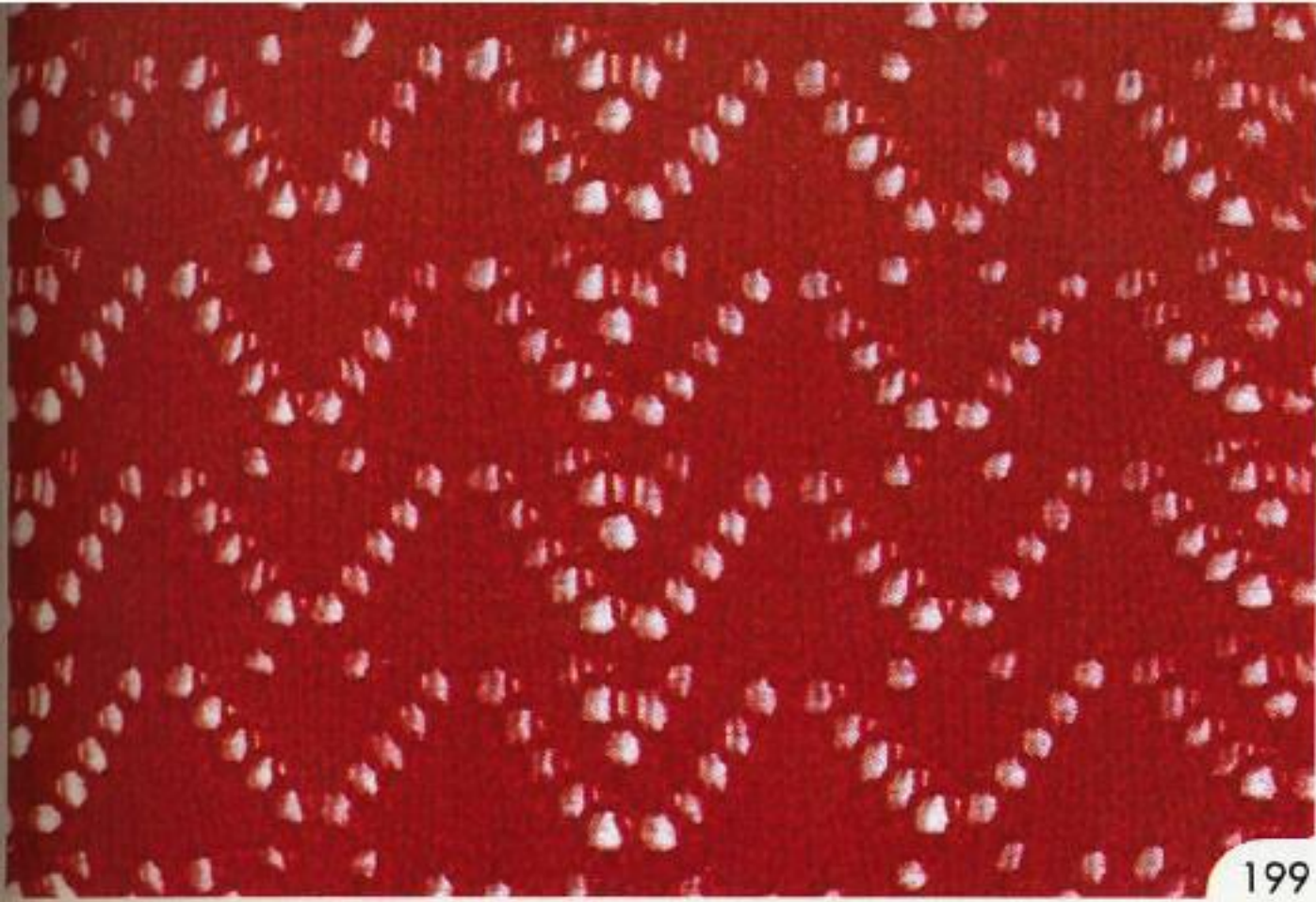
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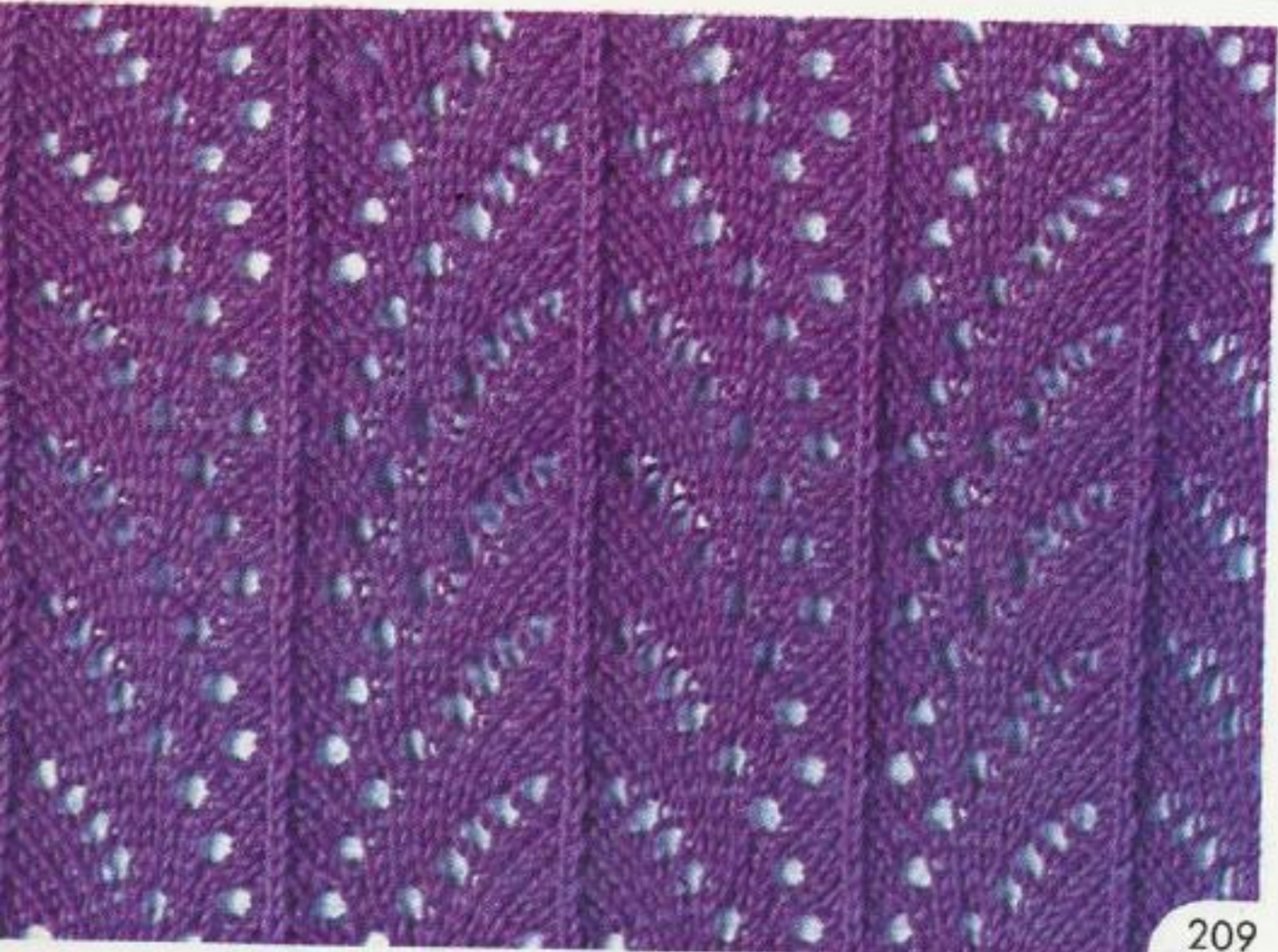
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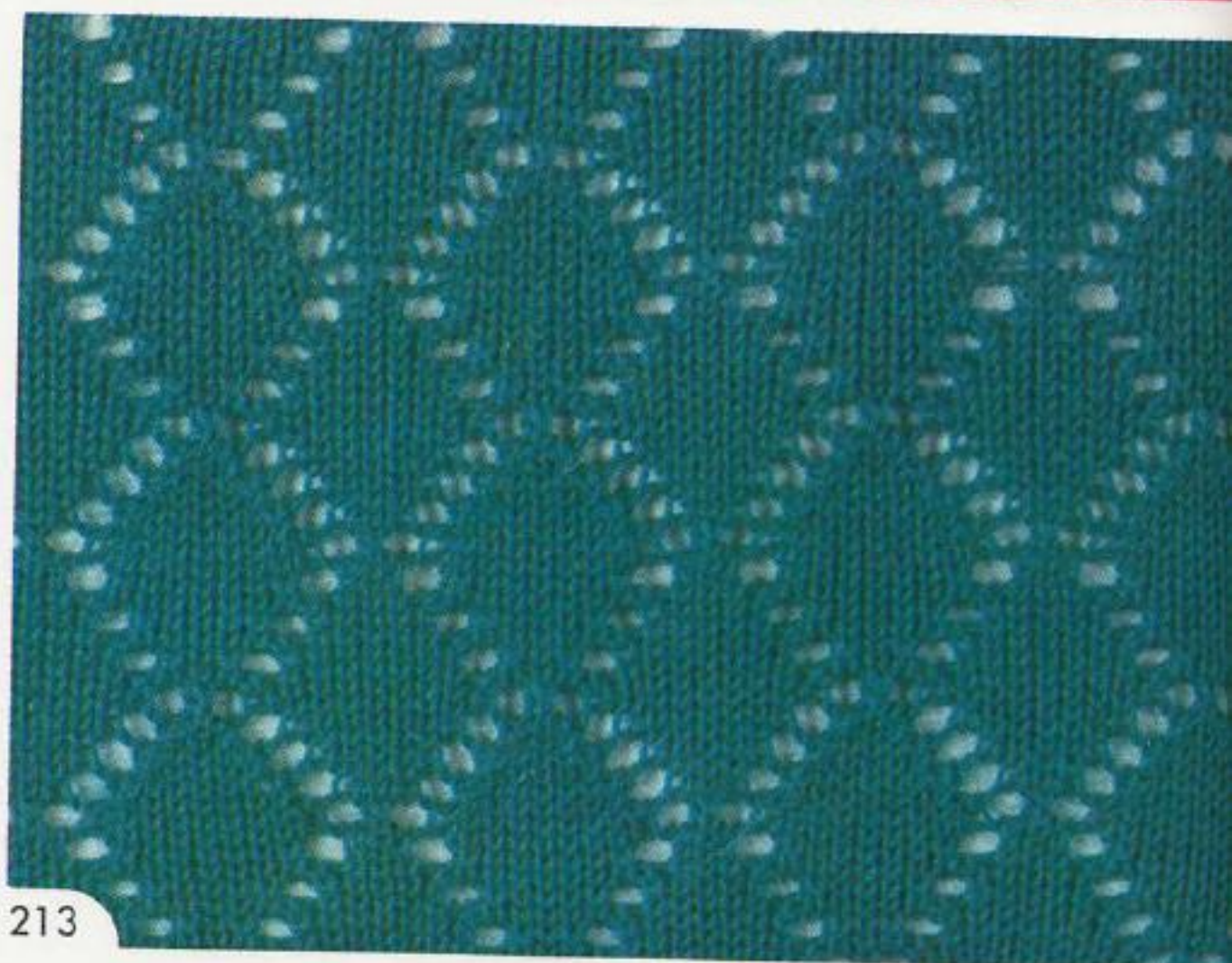
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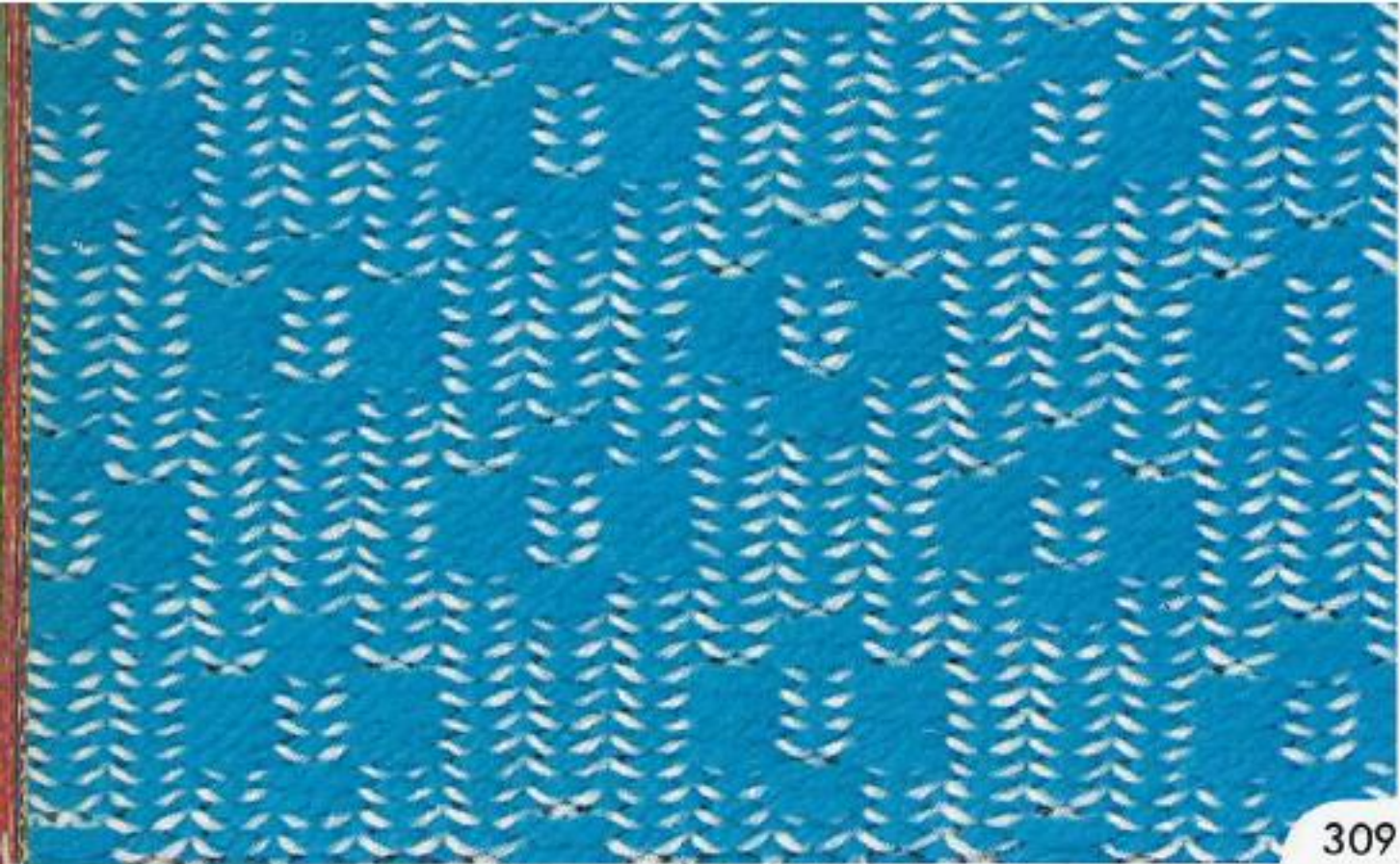
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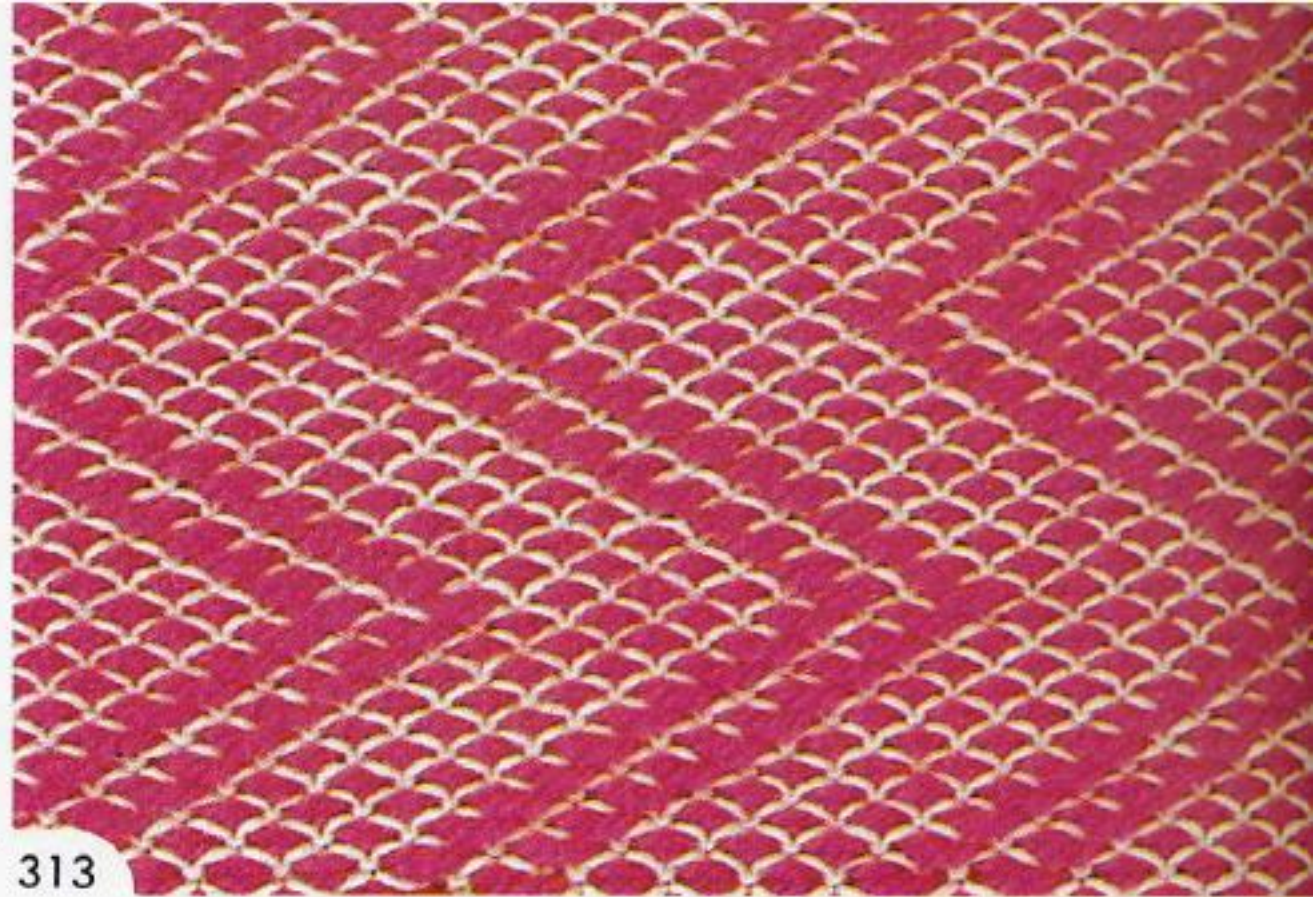
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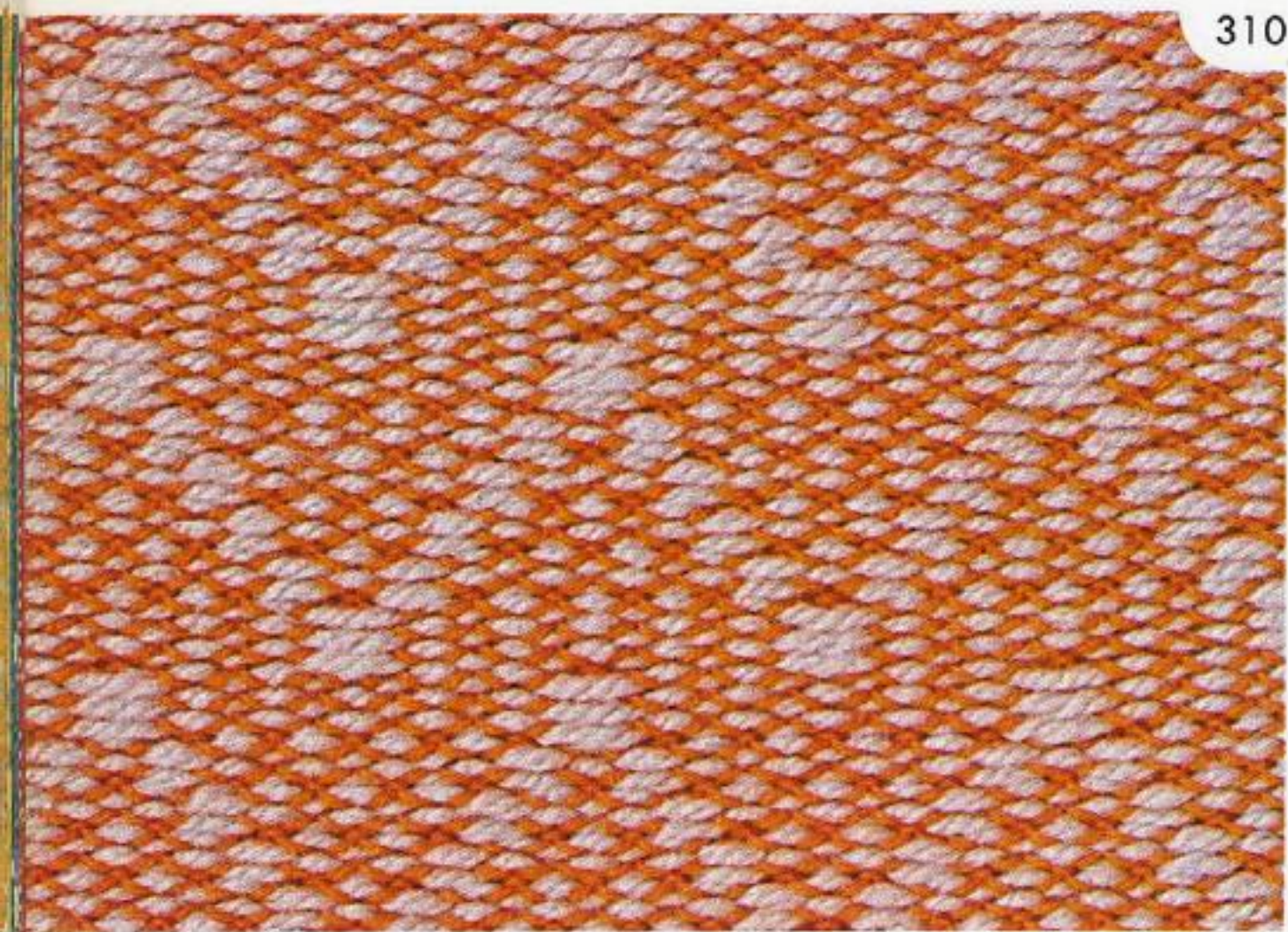
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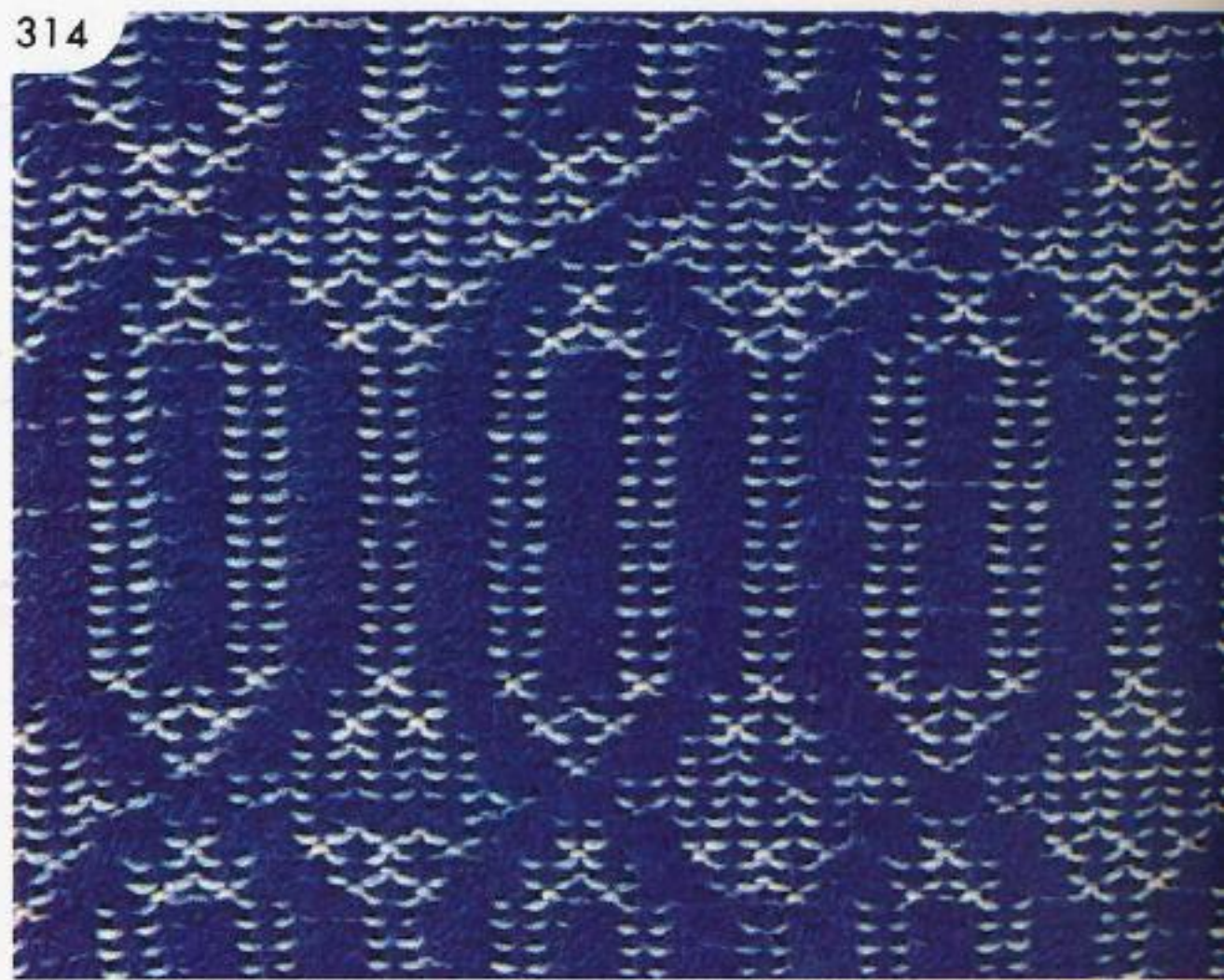
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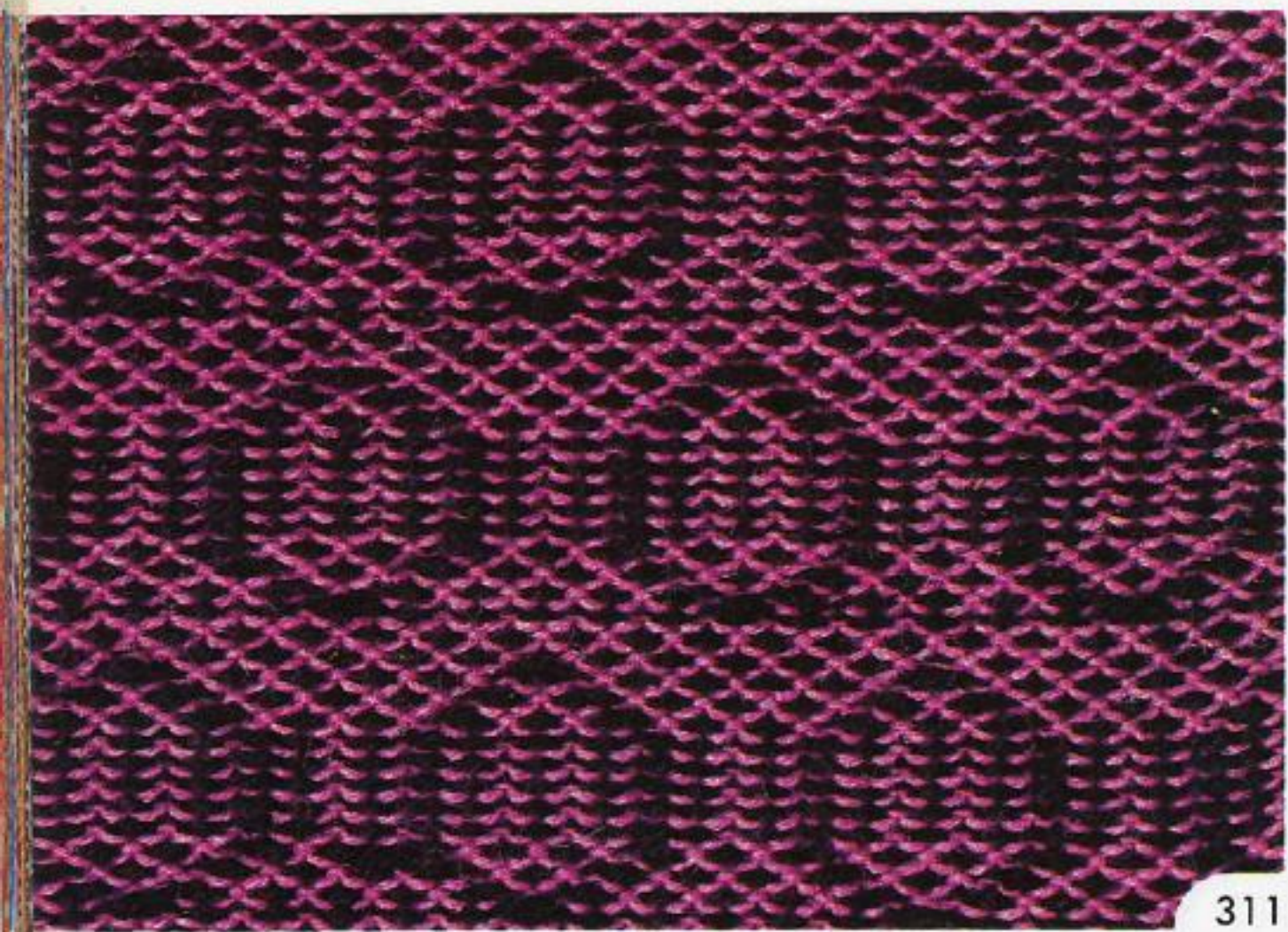
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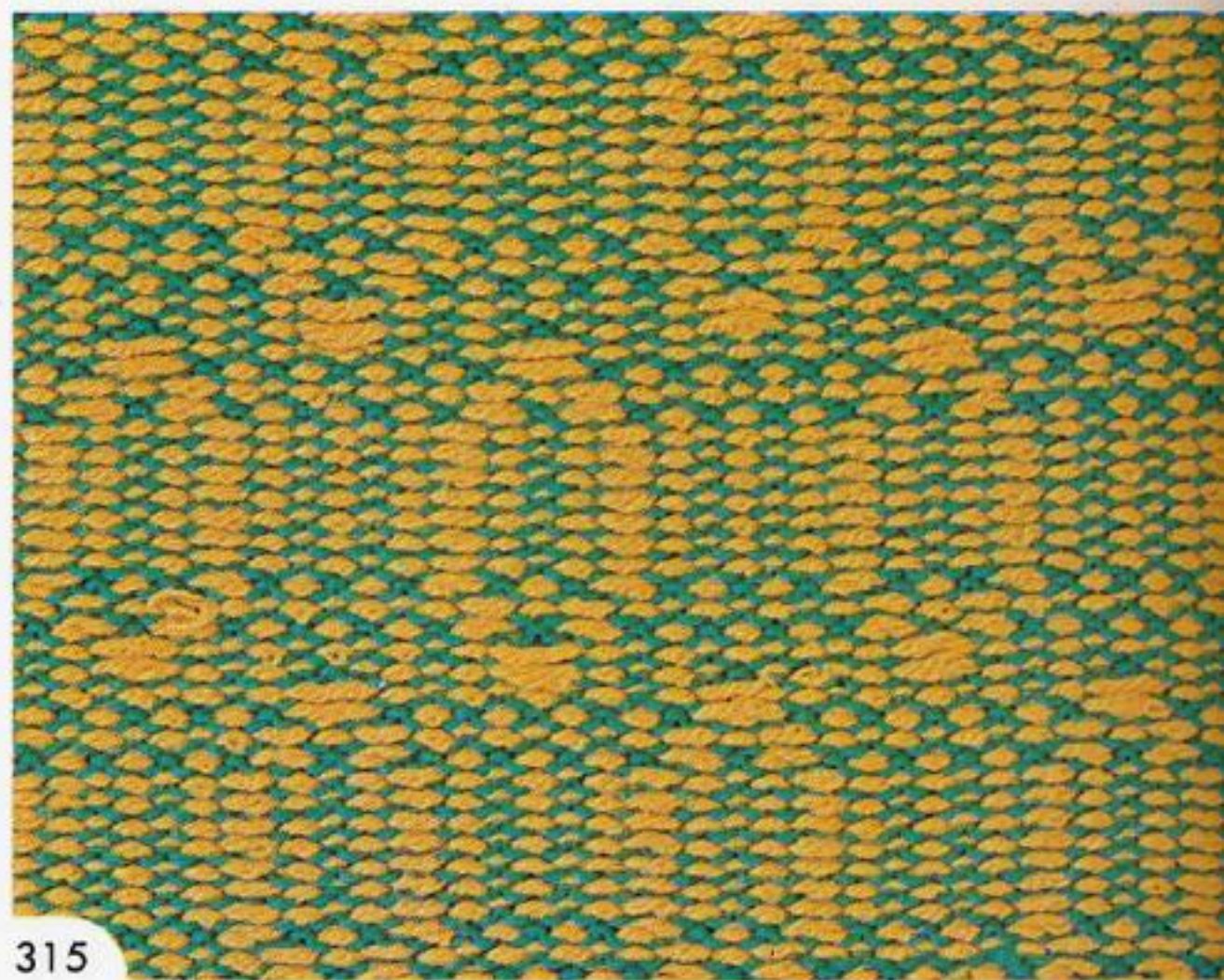
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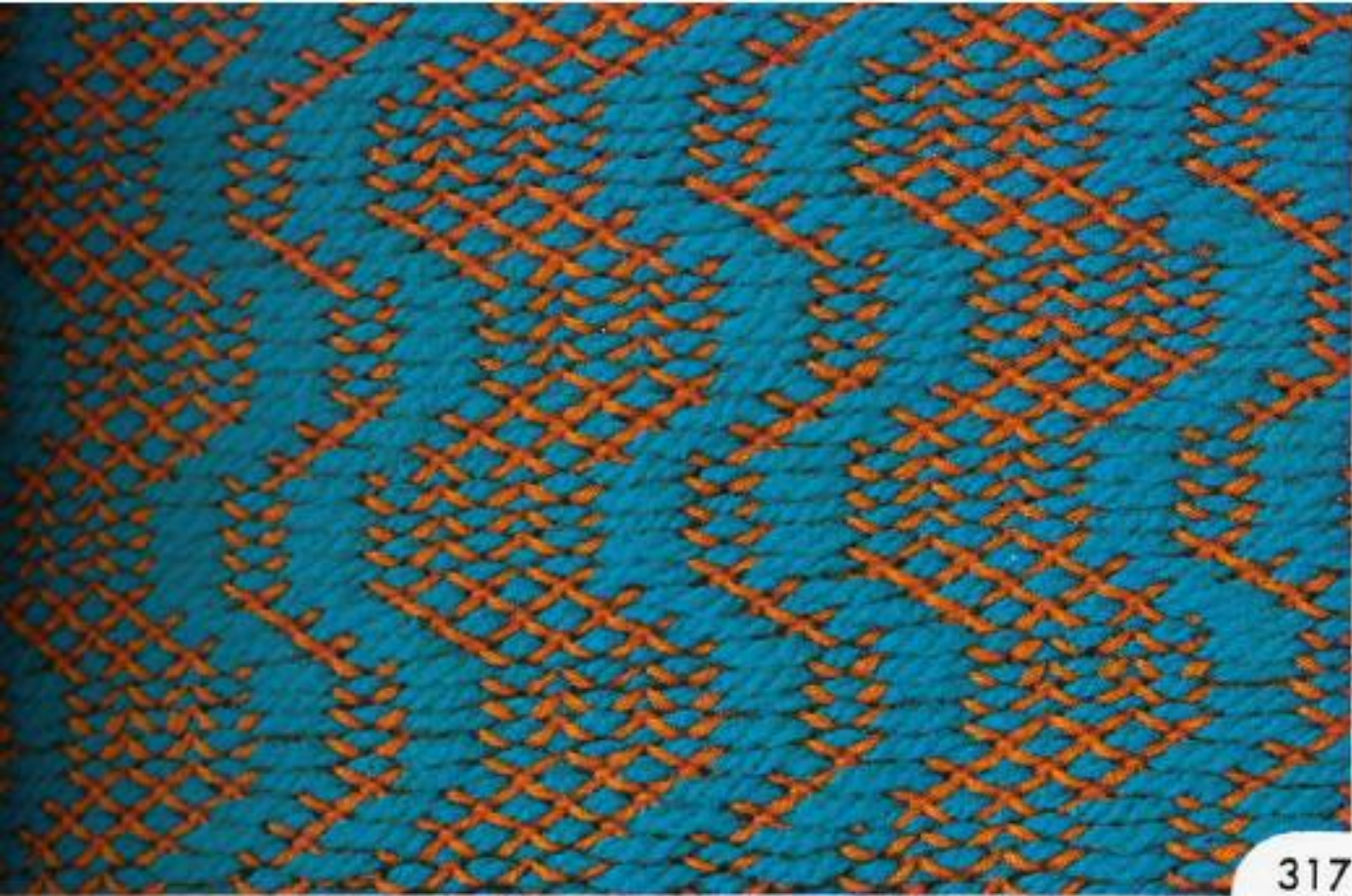
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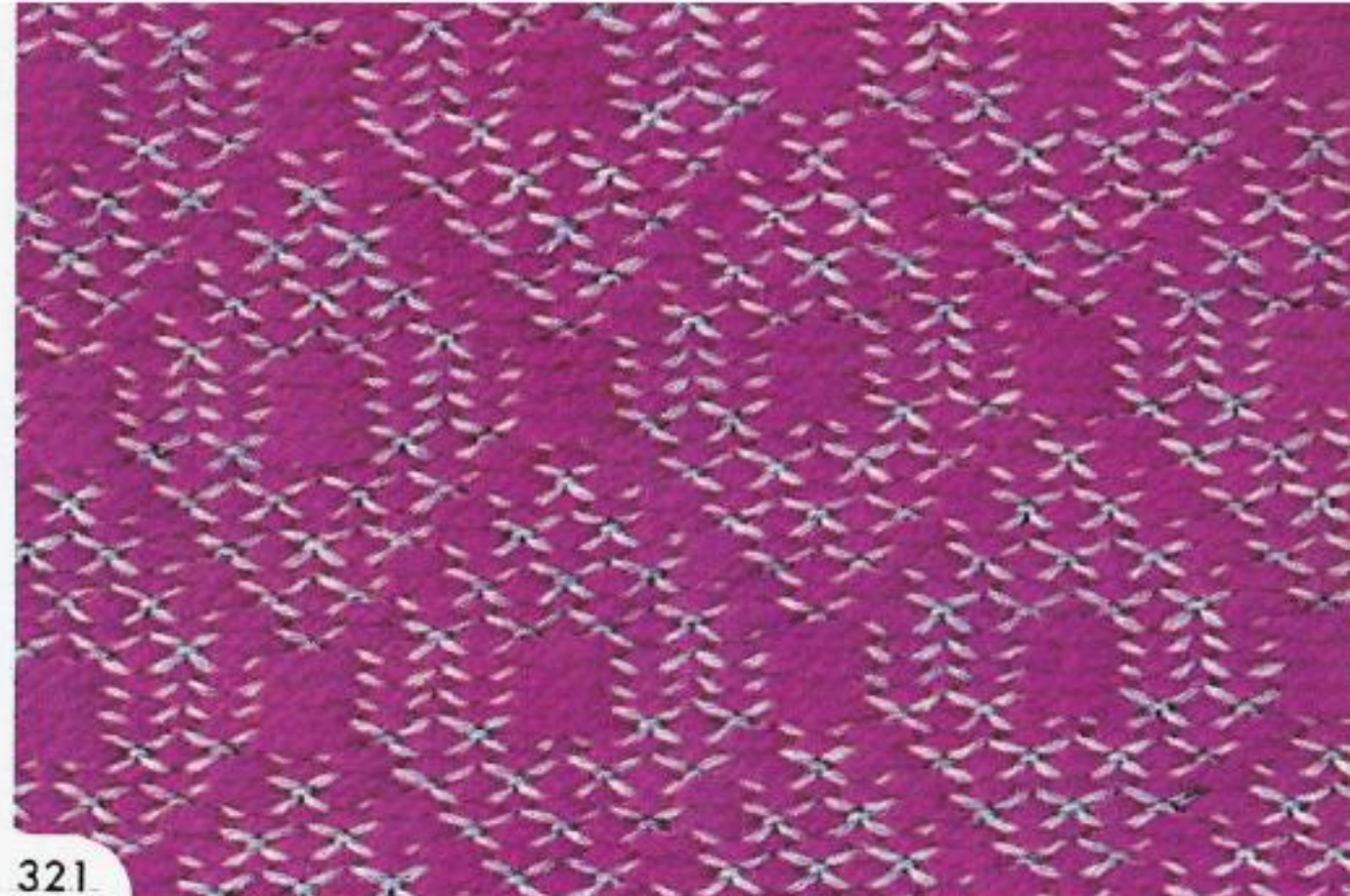
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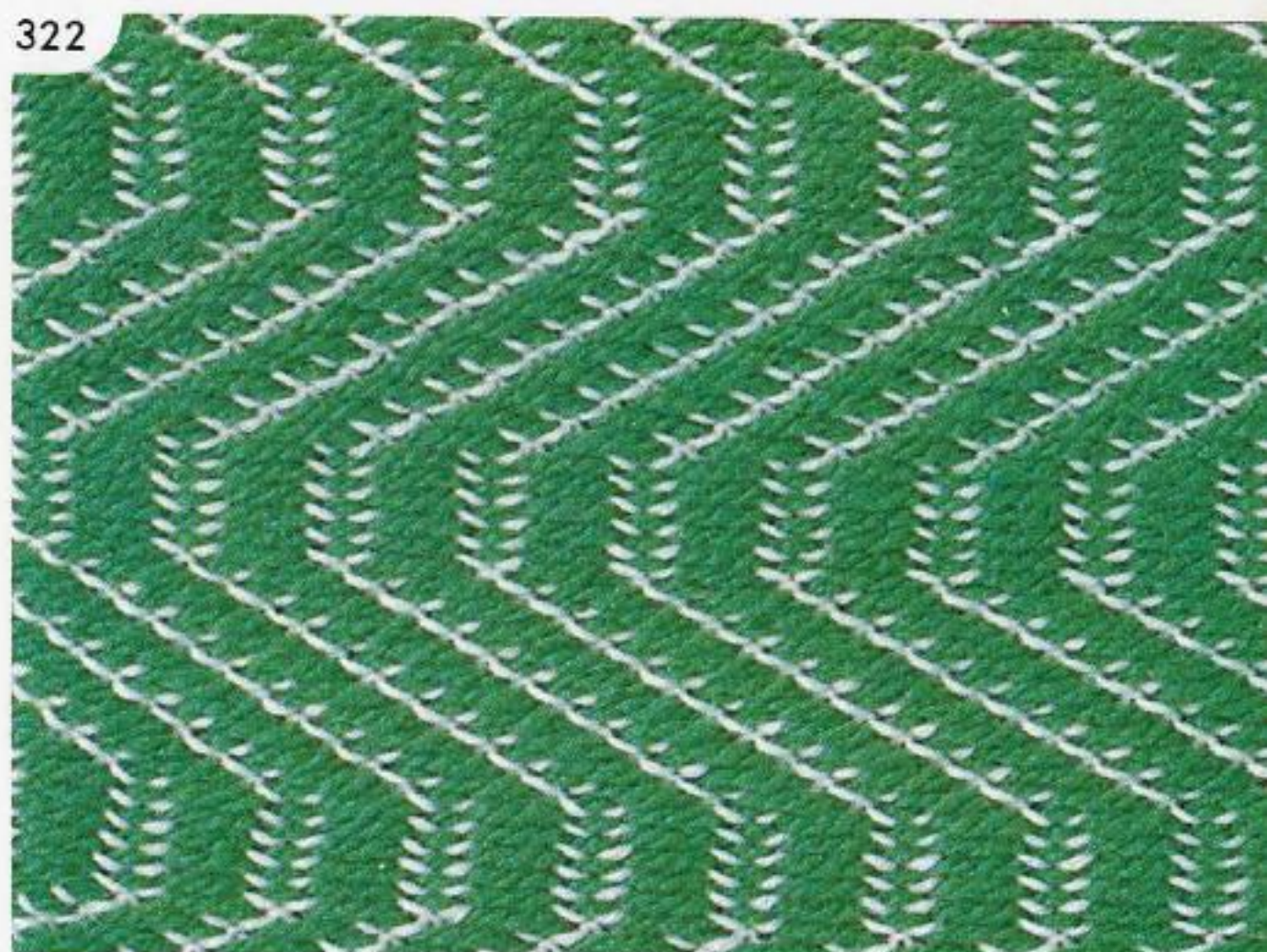
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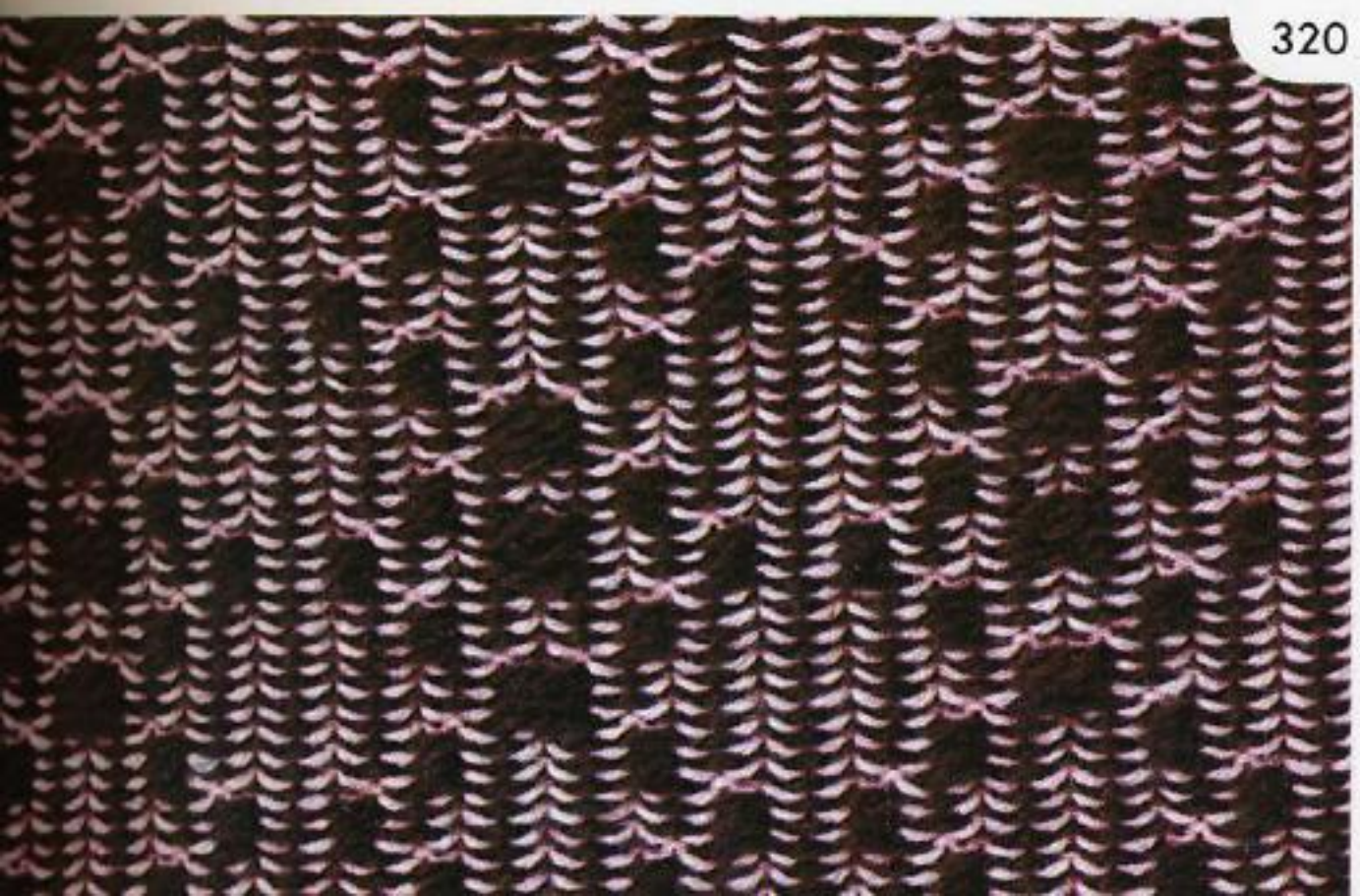
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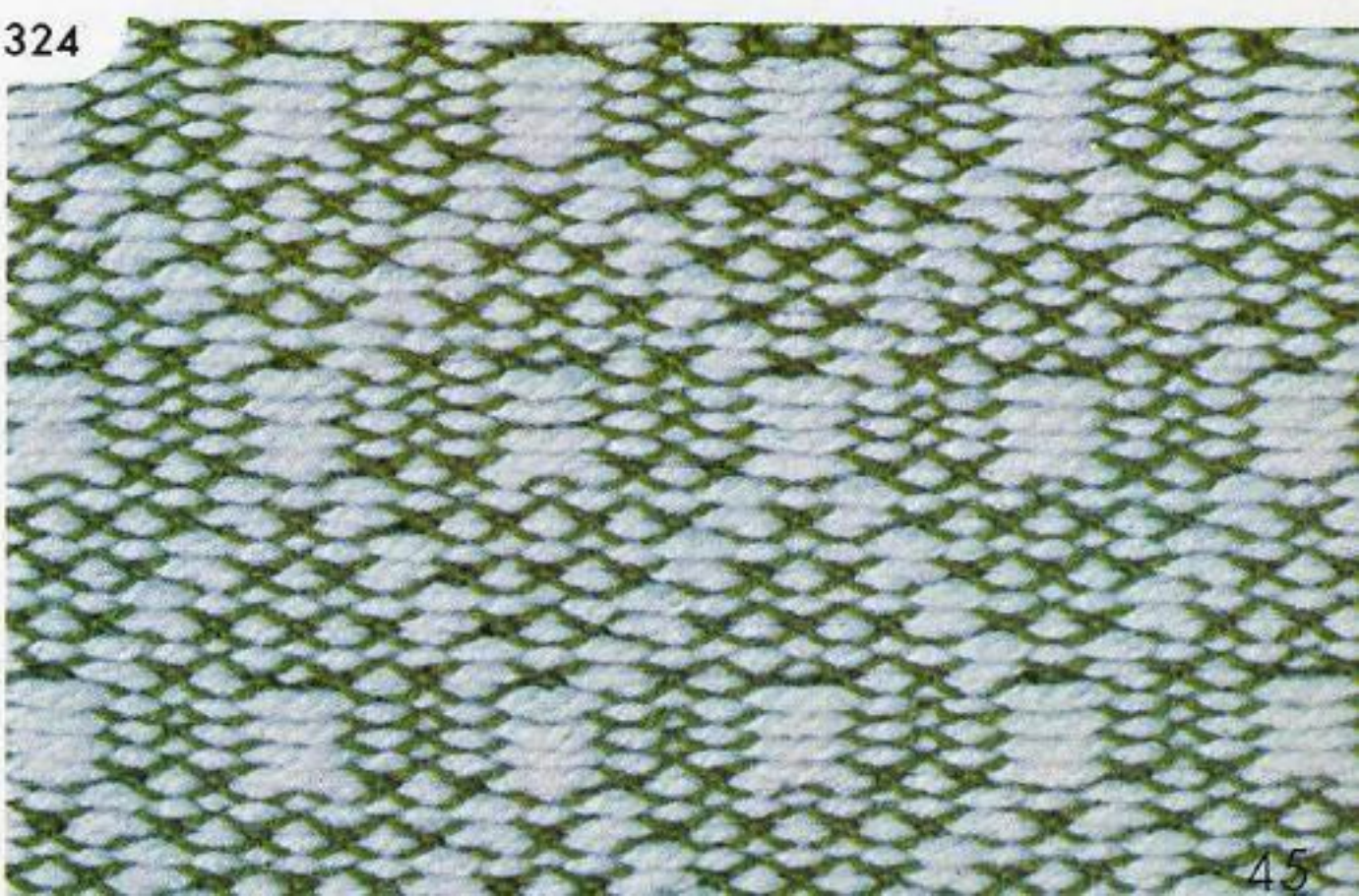
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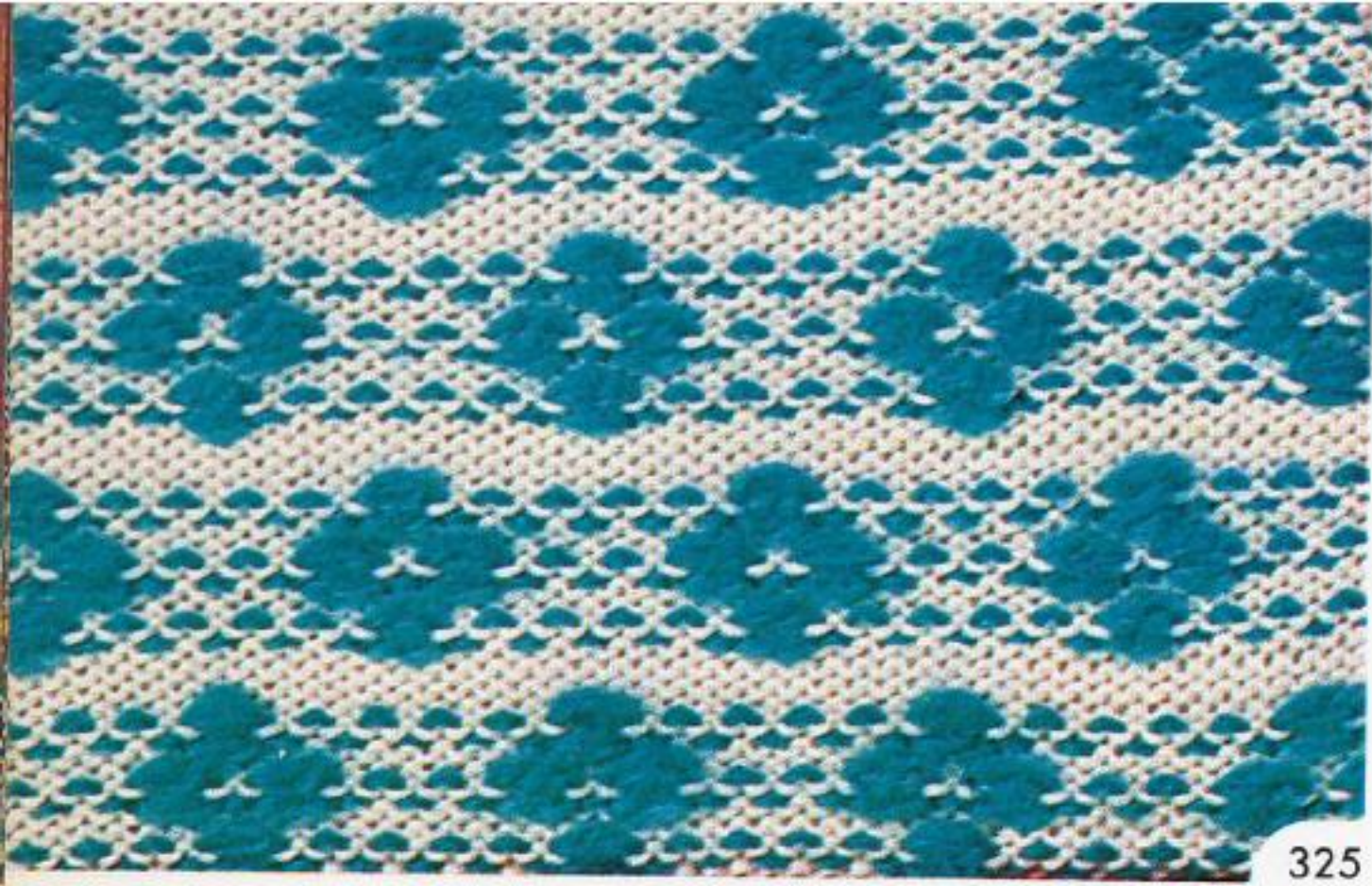
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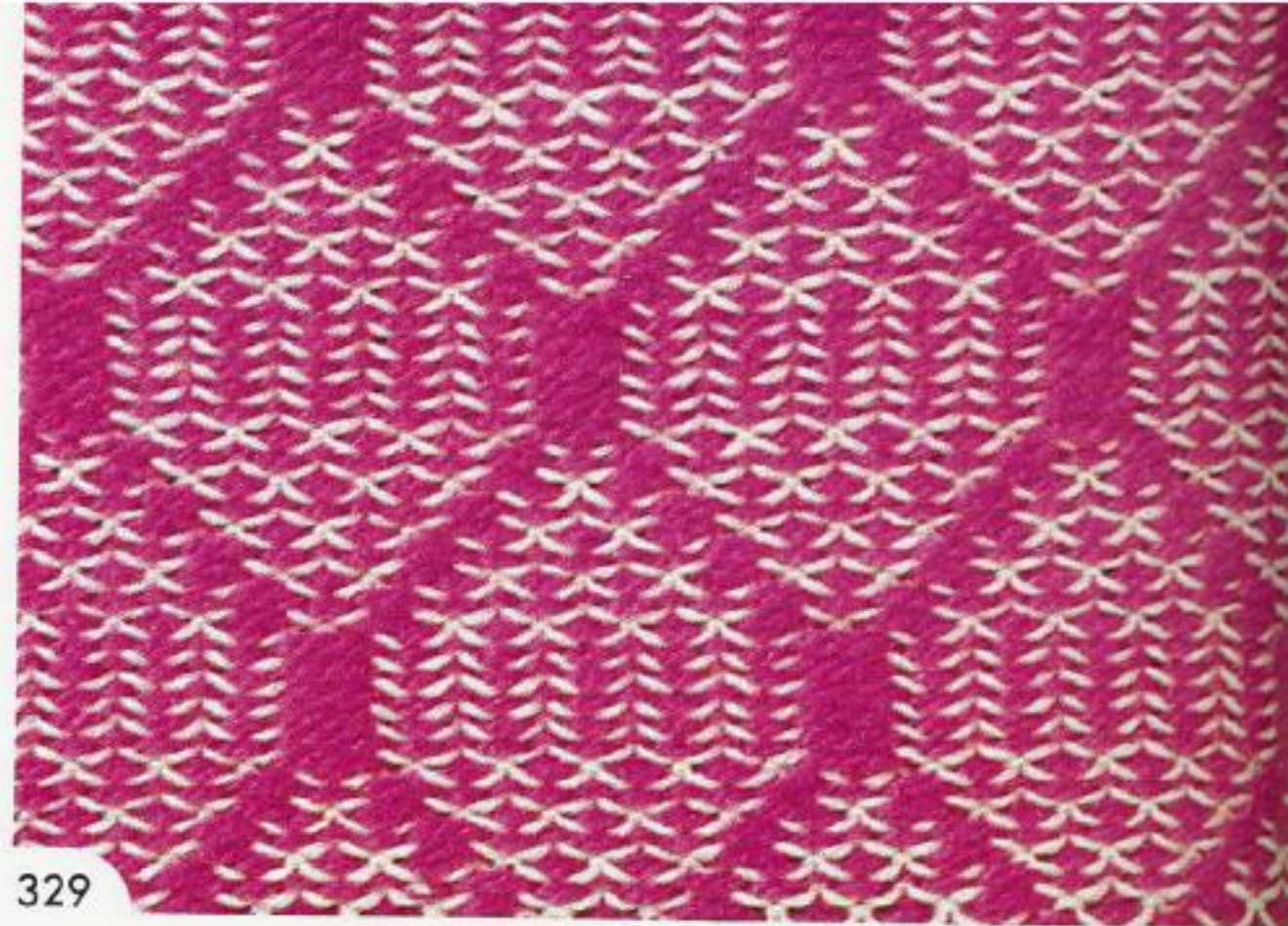
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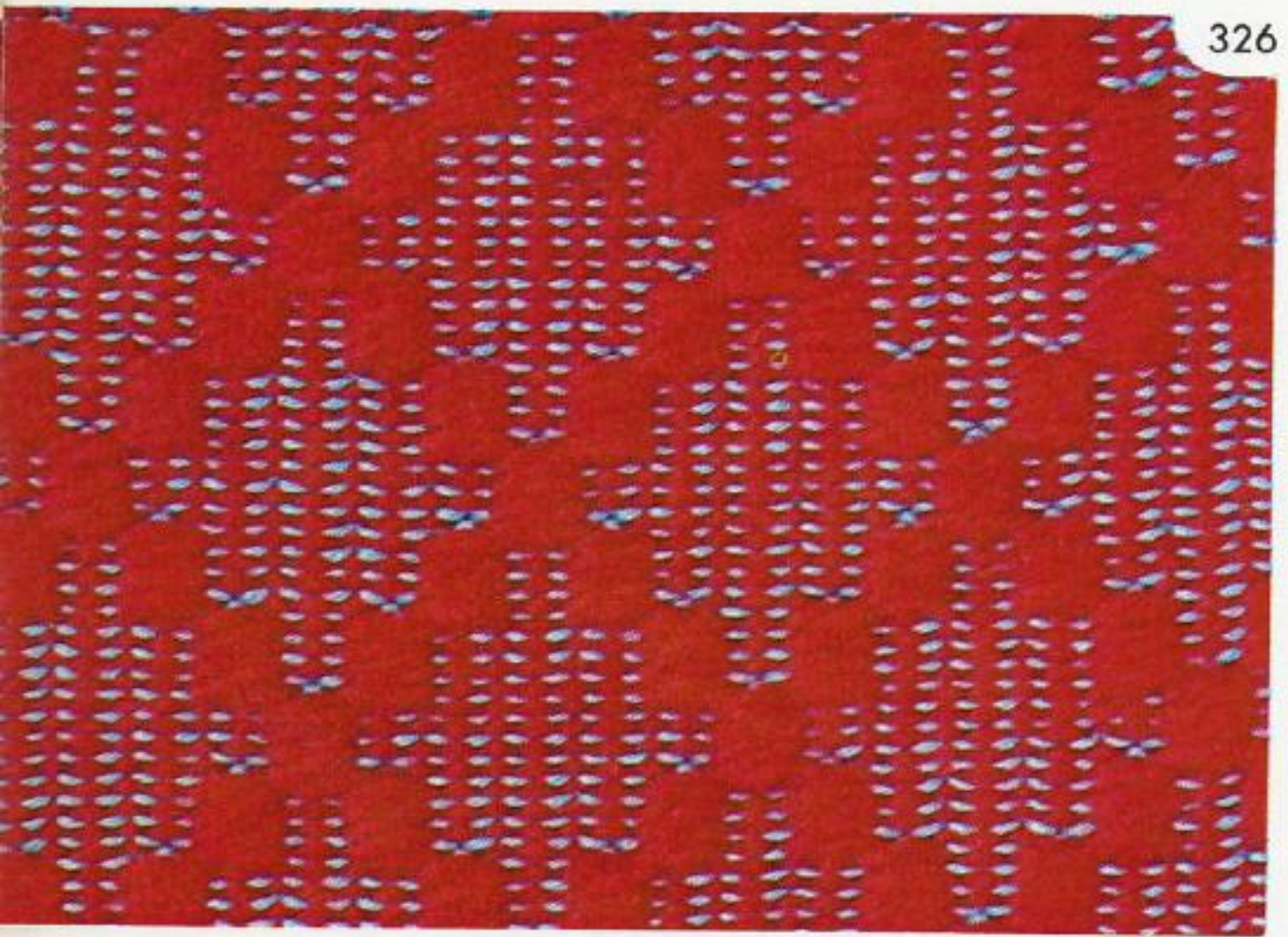
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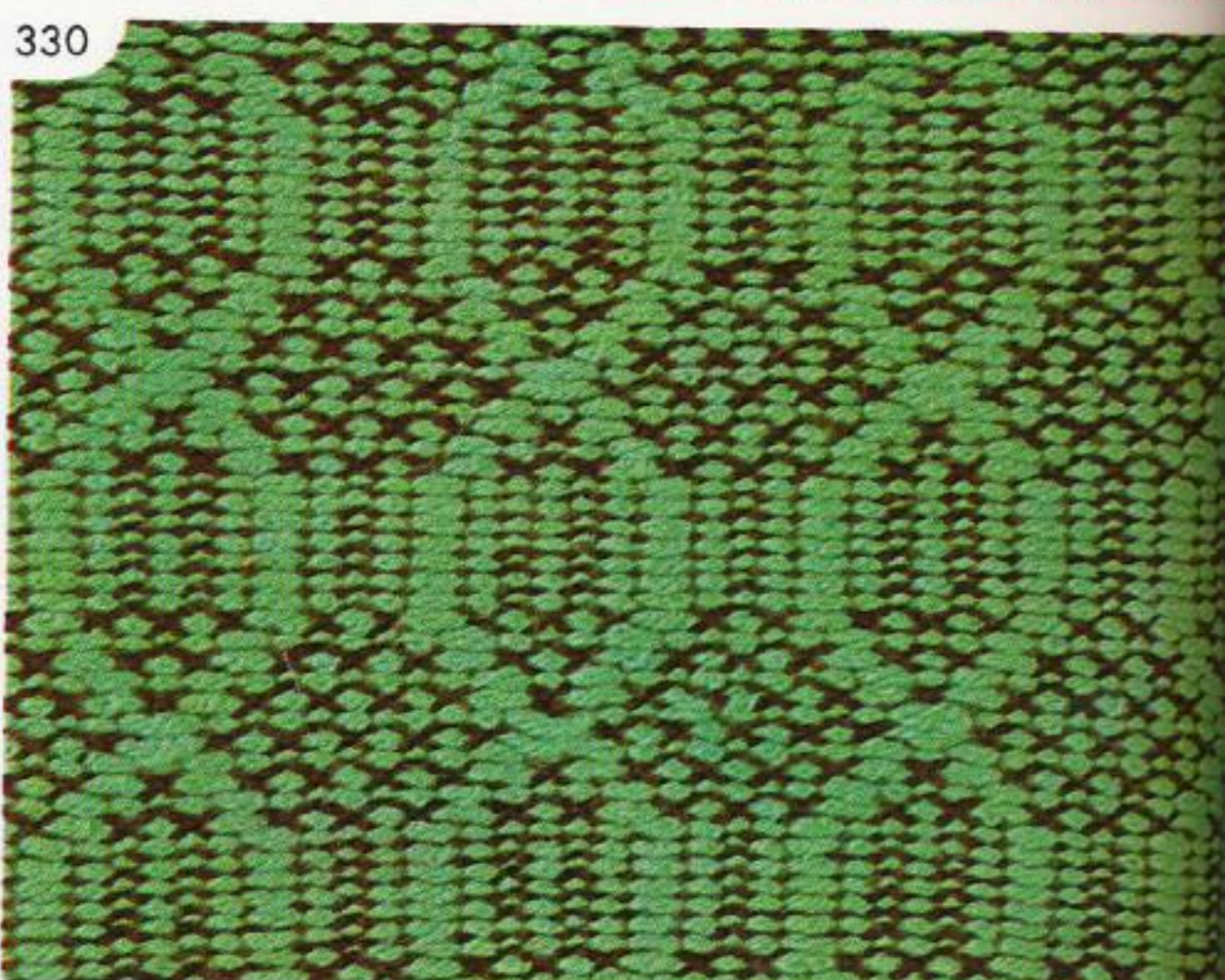
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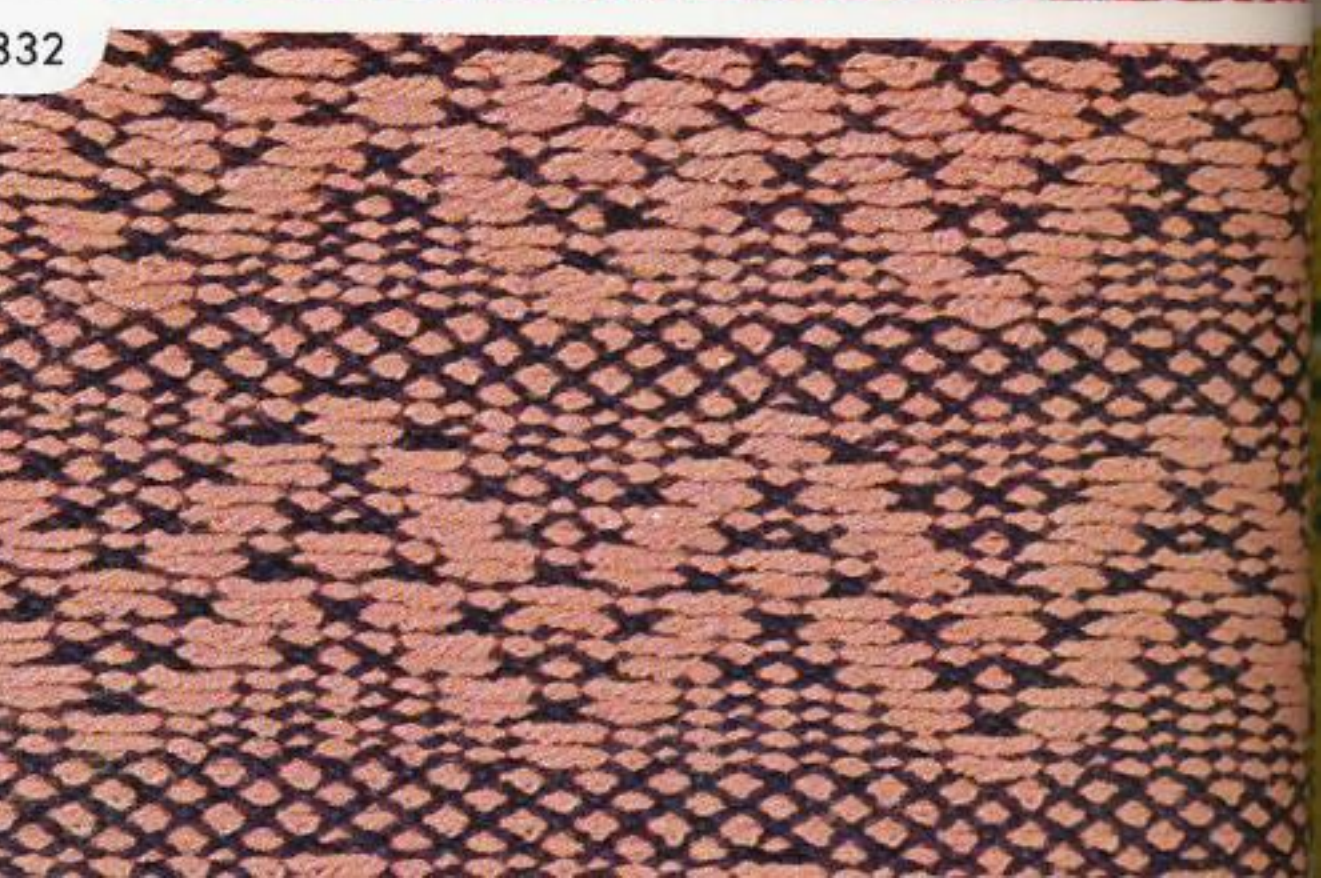
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Weaving pattern and the materials

Magic of knitting! Look at the pictures of the Weaving pattern. All of them were worked by weaving knitting using the same technique. As you see these pictures, by changing the Laying-in yarn quite different effects are obtained. Therefore following the examples included in this Knitting Pattern Book, more than hundred of different variations can be obtained by combining different types of yarn.

How to get the best effect in weaving knitting

1. We recommend using a finer yarn for basic knitting and a heavier yarn or a fancy yarn for weaving thread. This way you will get the effect of an interesting contrast and at the same time you can reduce the weight of the garment which you are making.
2. Pay special attention to the contrast of the colors of basic knitting and weaving thread. Always match them up by doing a sample piece.
3. It is necessary to set the number on the tension dial according to the weaving thread. Usually one graduation lower tension is used for weaving than for plain knitting. Do not set the tension too tight or the weaving thread may catch in the stitches formed.

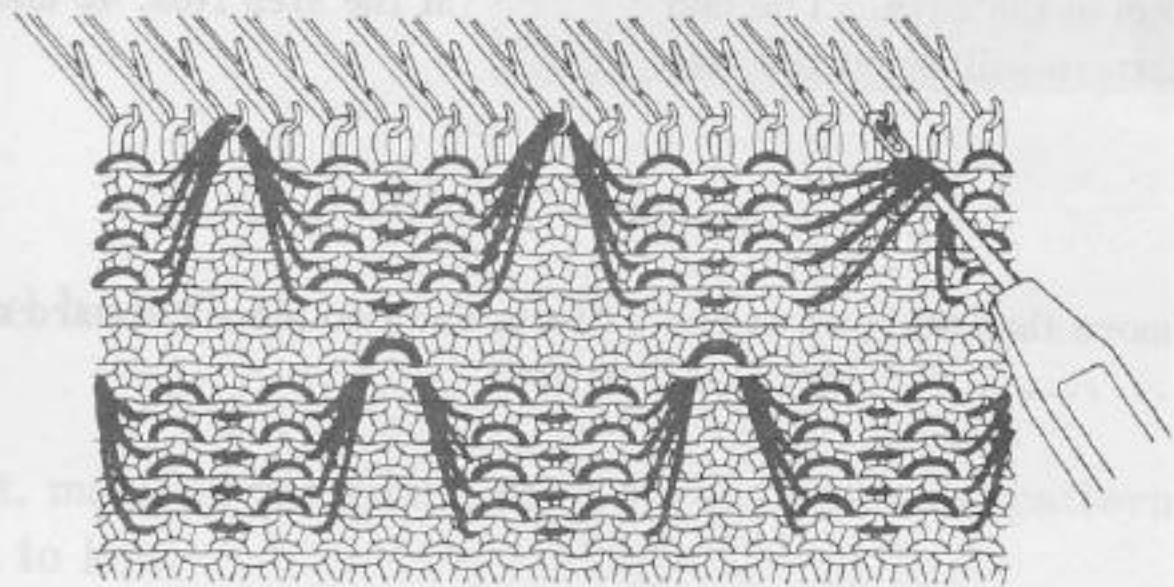
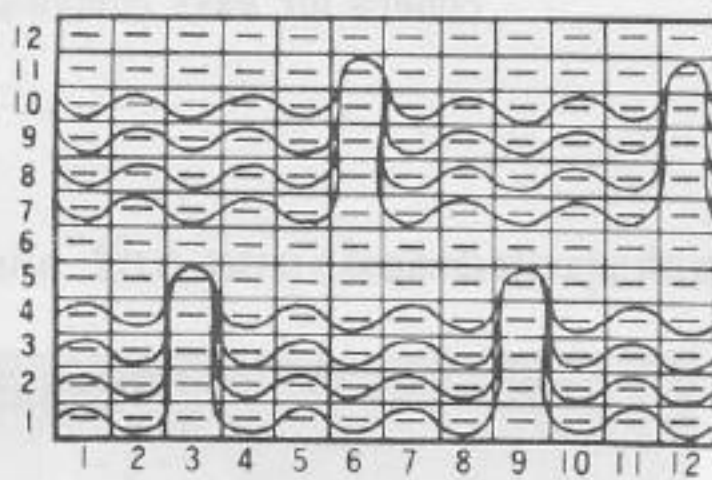
Special methods for making the Weaving patterns

There are three kind of methods for Weaving pattern knitting to get the fantastic pattern.

1. Pulling up the weaving thread.
2. Knitting by using the Latch tool.
3. Winding the weaving thread around the selected needles.

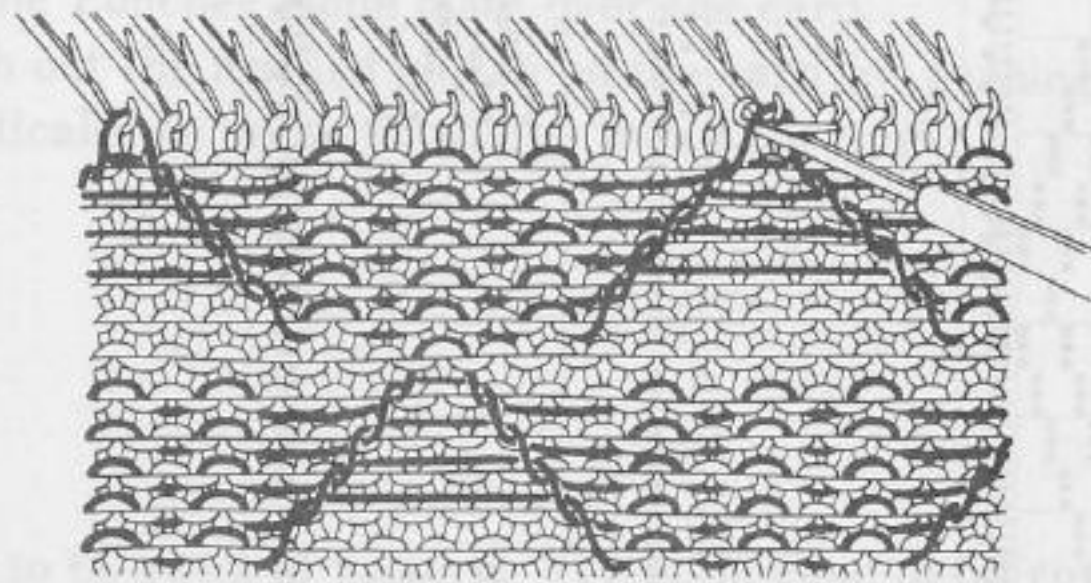
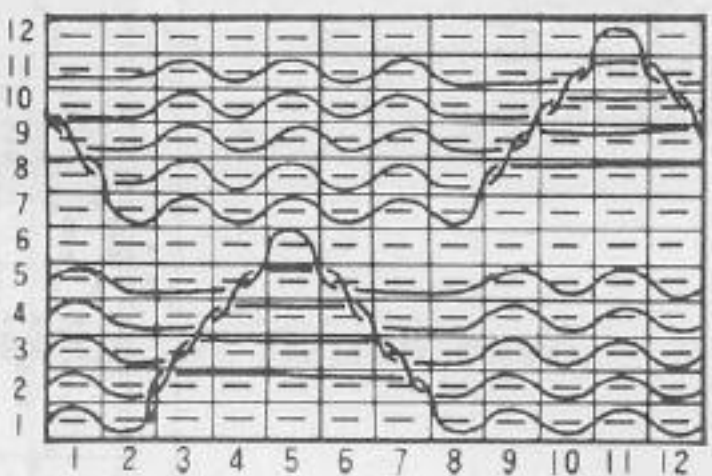
Knit a pattern by making reference to the Symbols of stitch.

(1) Pulling-up



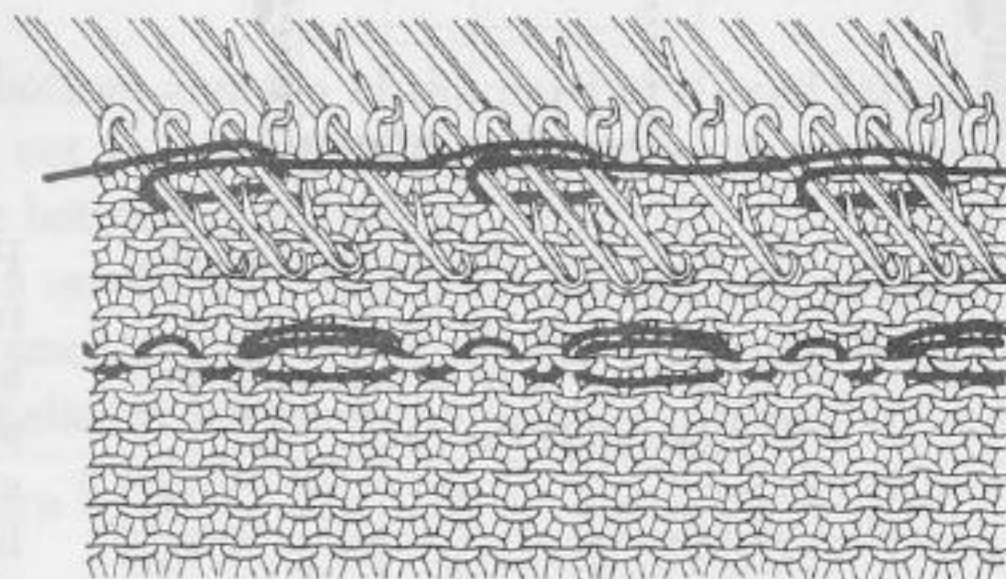
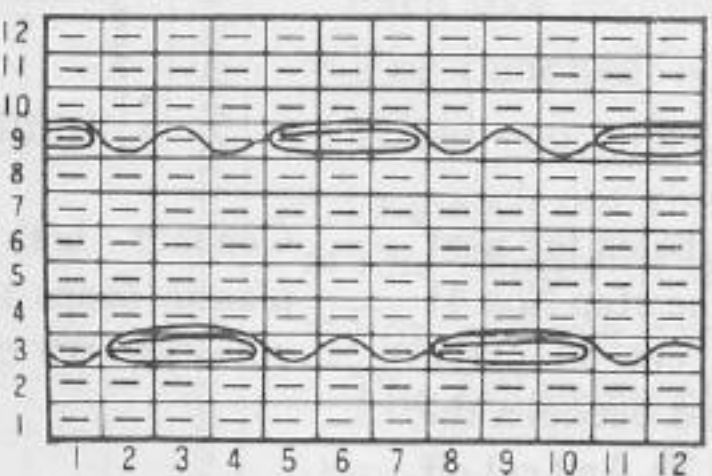
Pick up 4 weaving threads which are crossing in front of 3 knit stitches and put onto the needle on the 5th row.

(2) Knitting



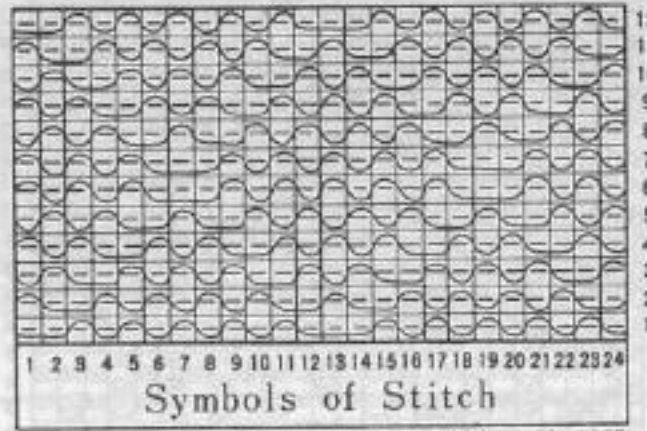
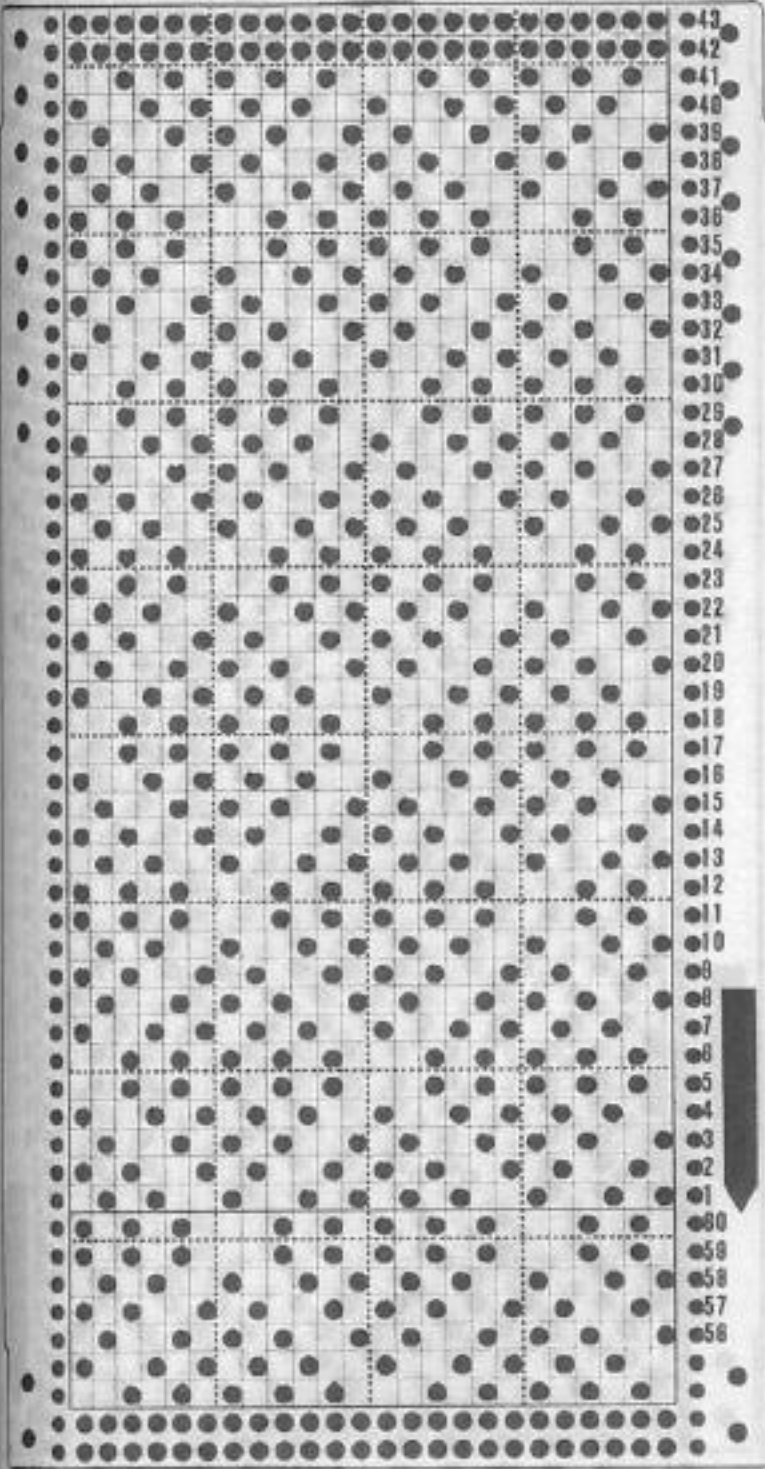
Work knit stitch of 5 weaving threads crossing in front of 7 stitches and put the last stitch on to the hook on the 6th row.

(3) Winding

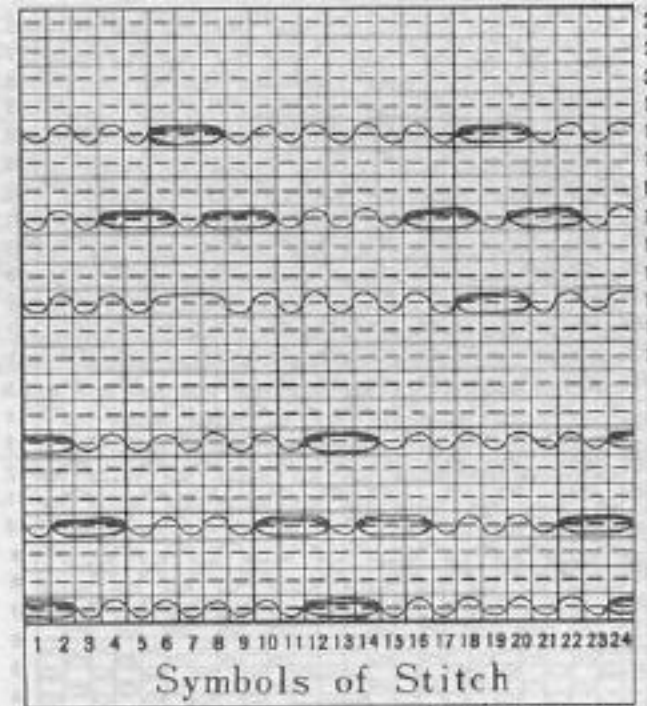


Bring forward the selected needles to position E, and wind the weaving thread around the stem of the needles.

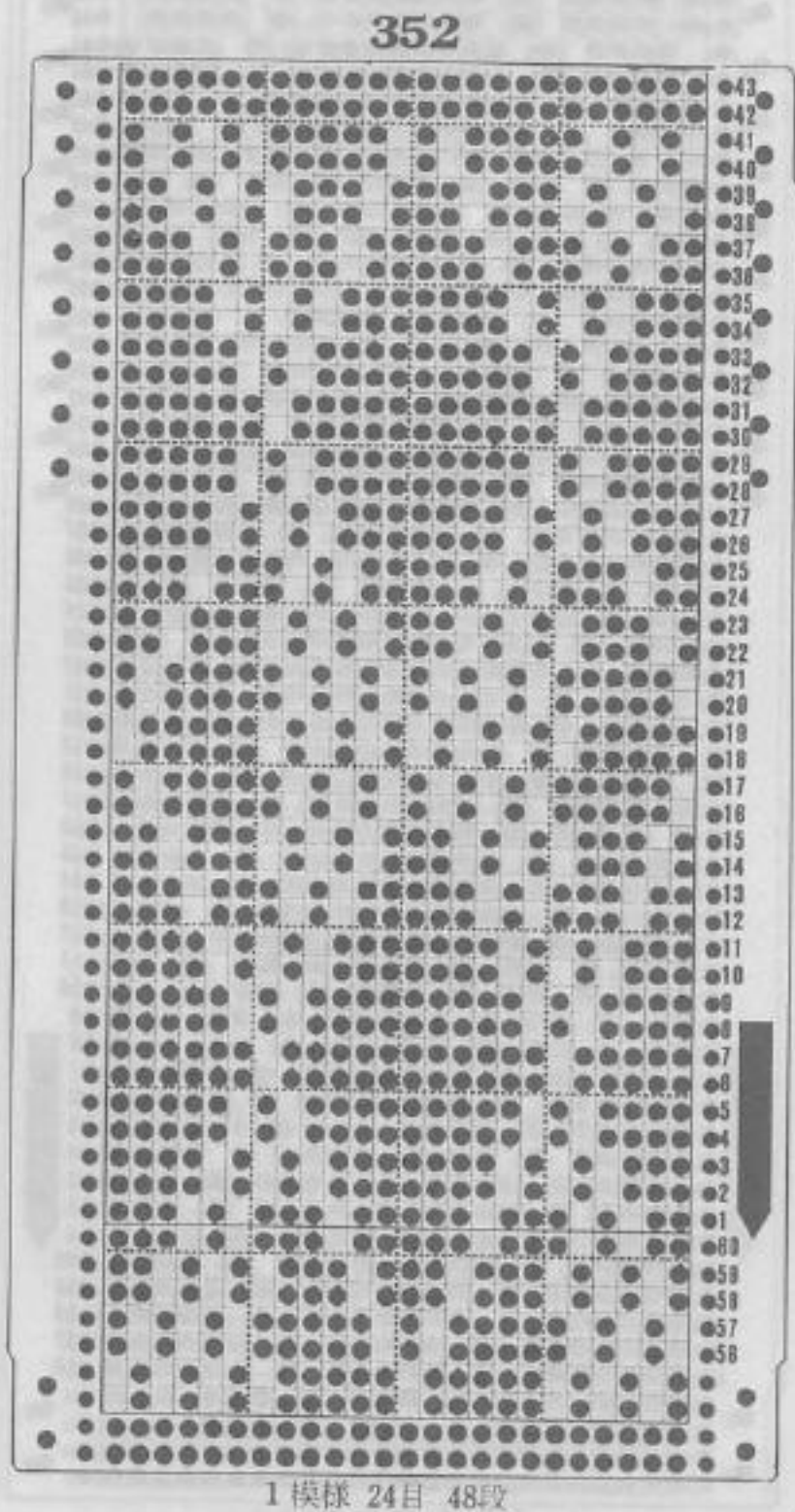
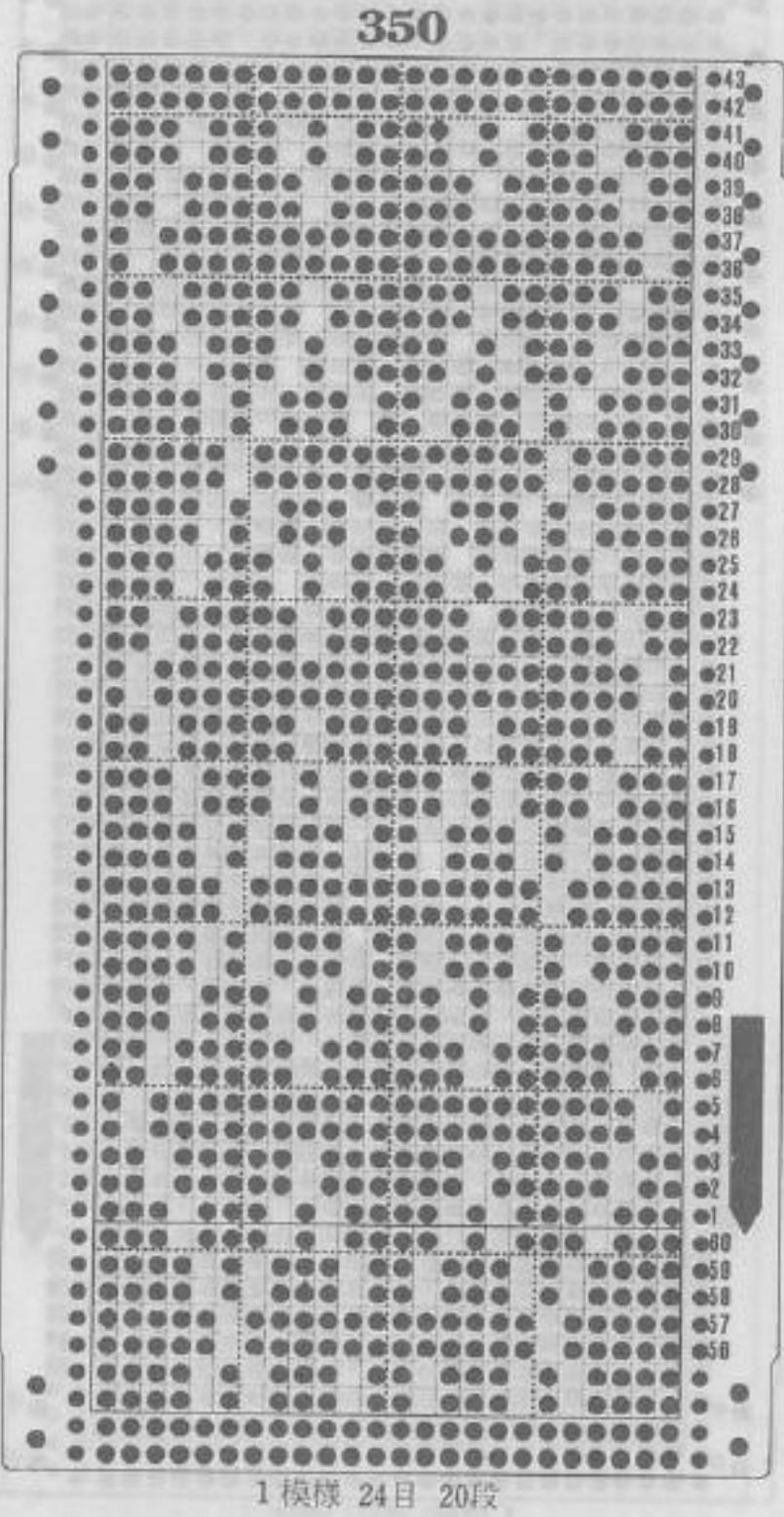
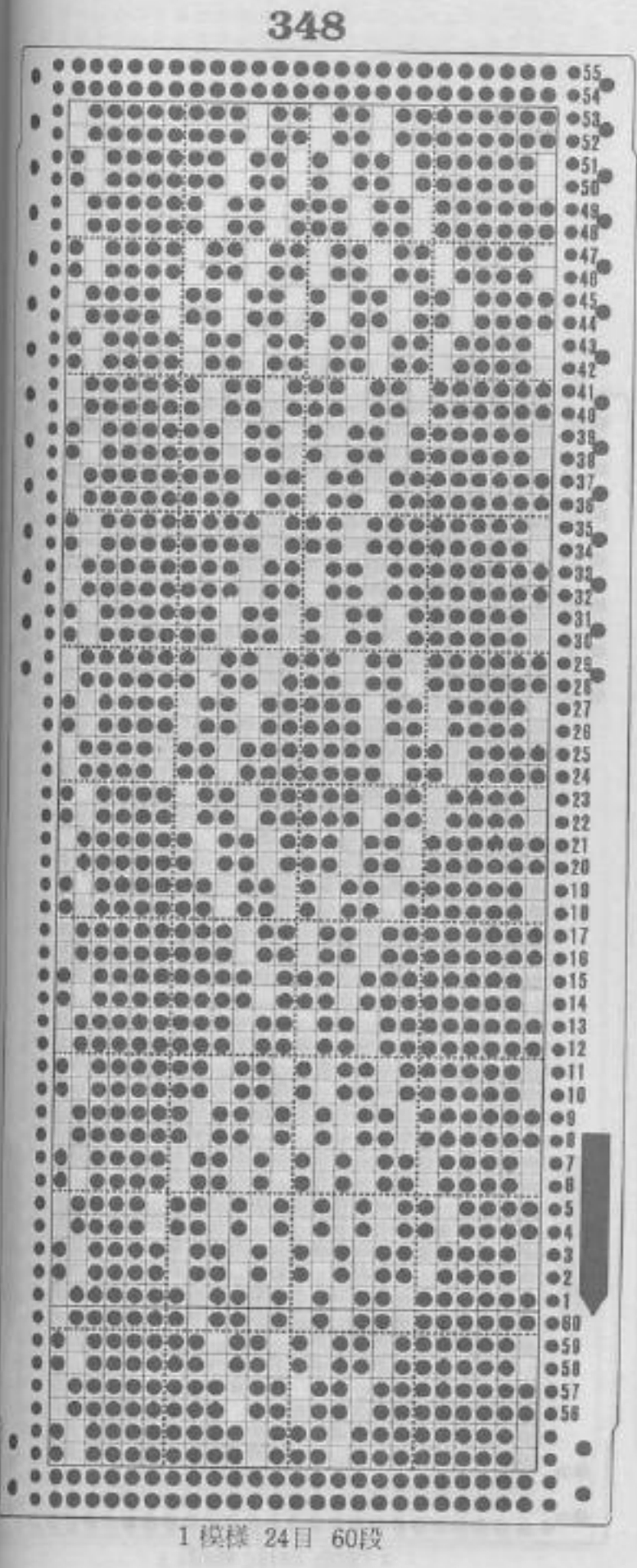
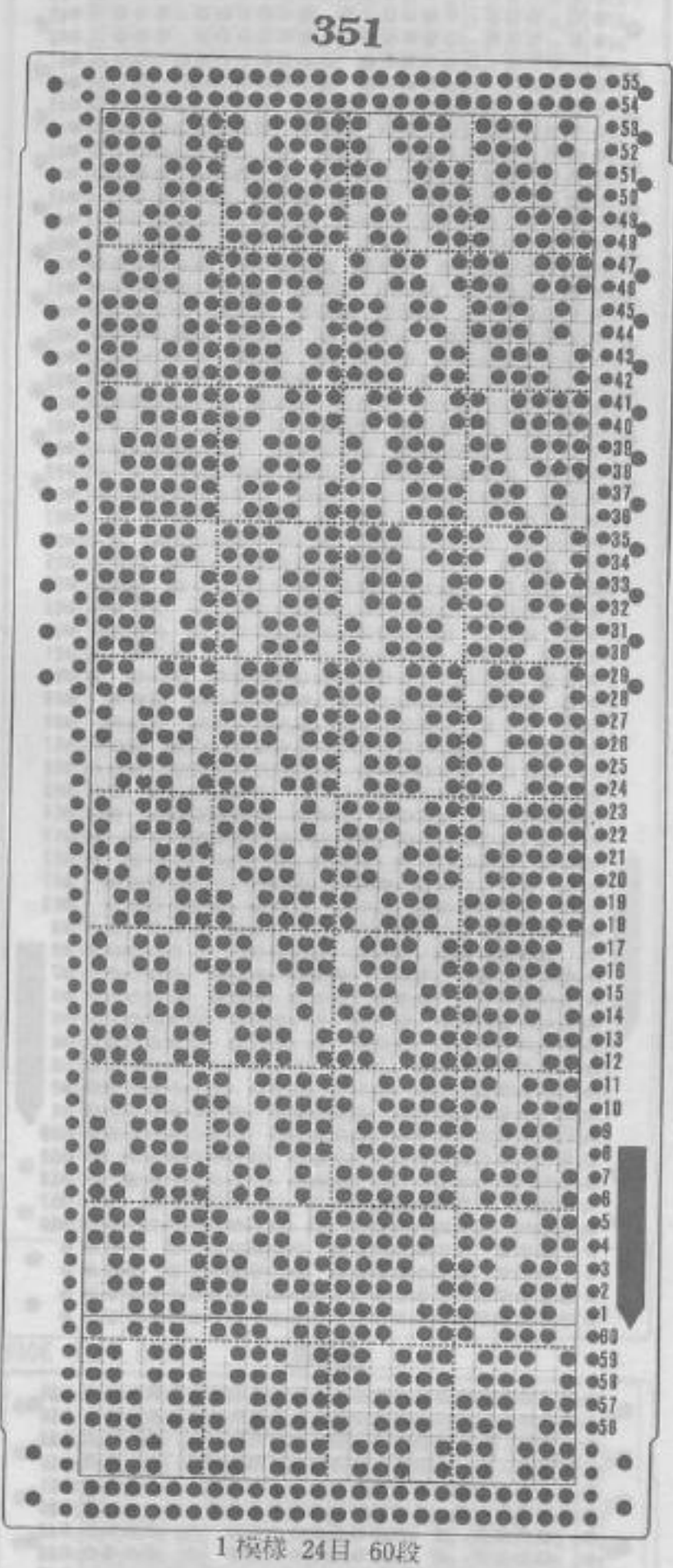
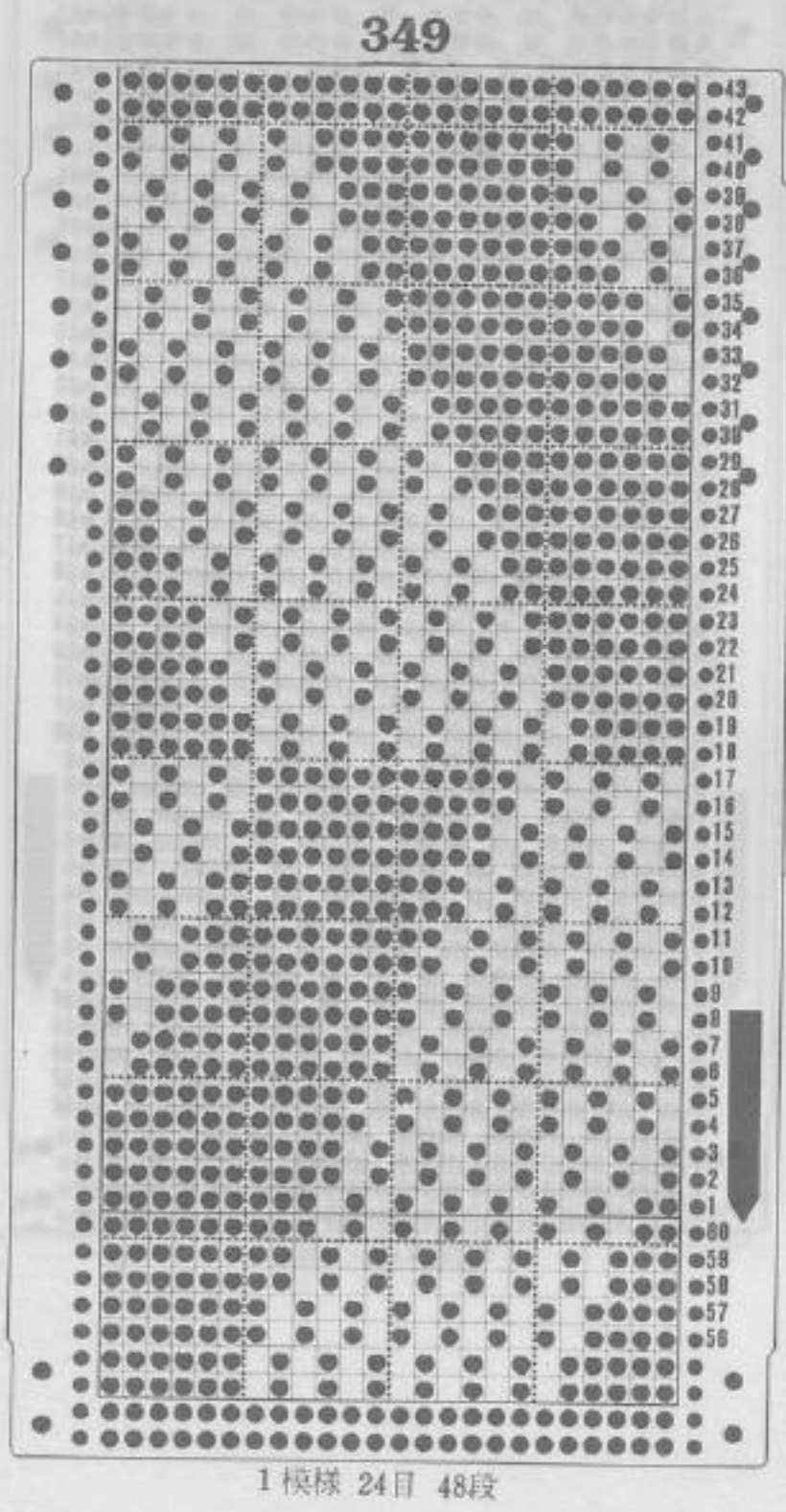
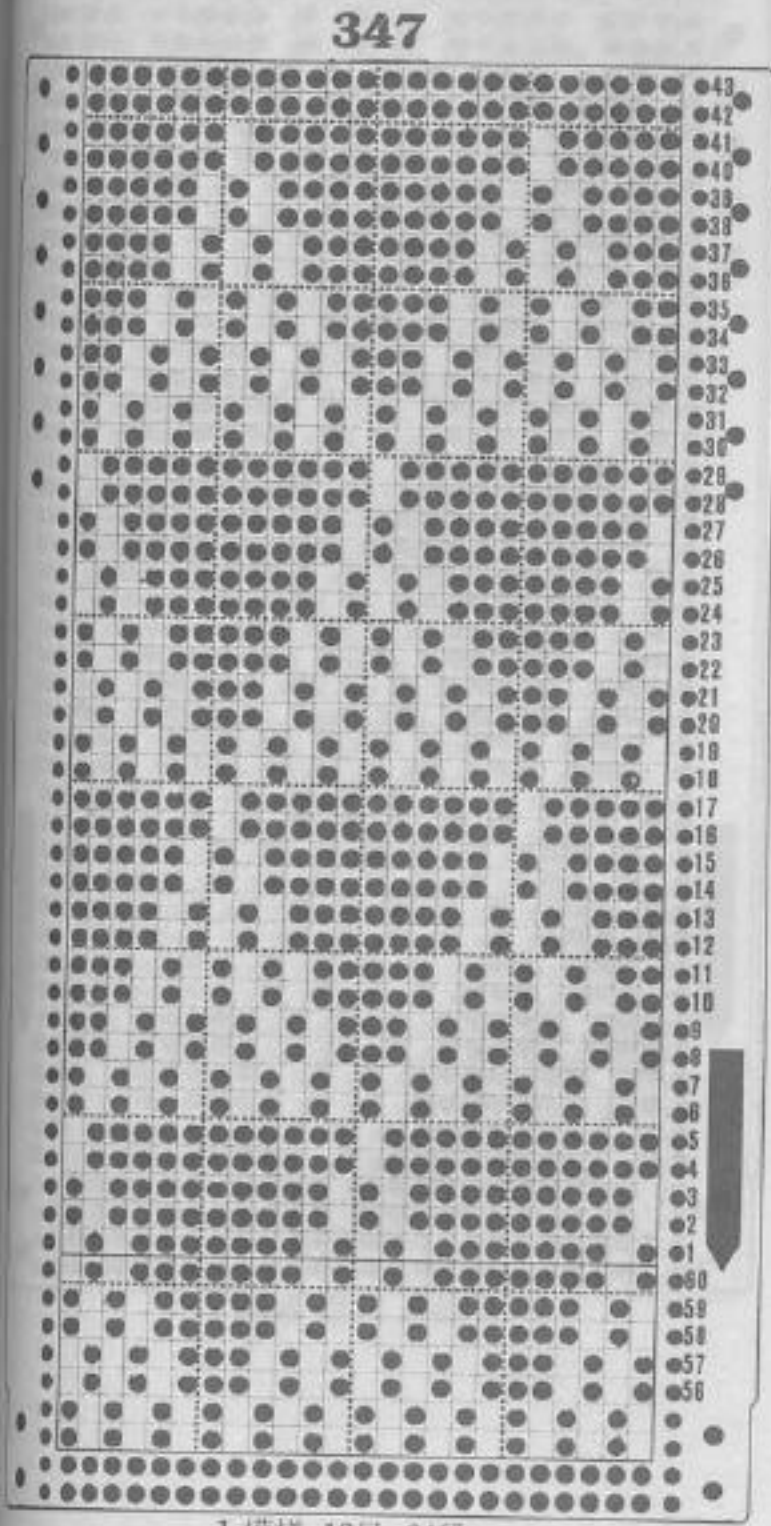


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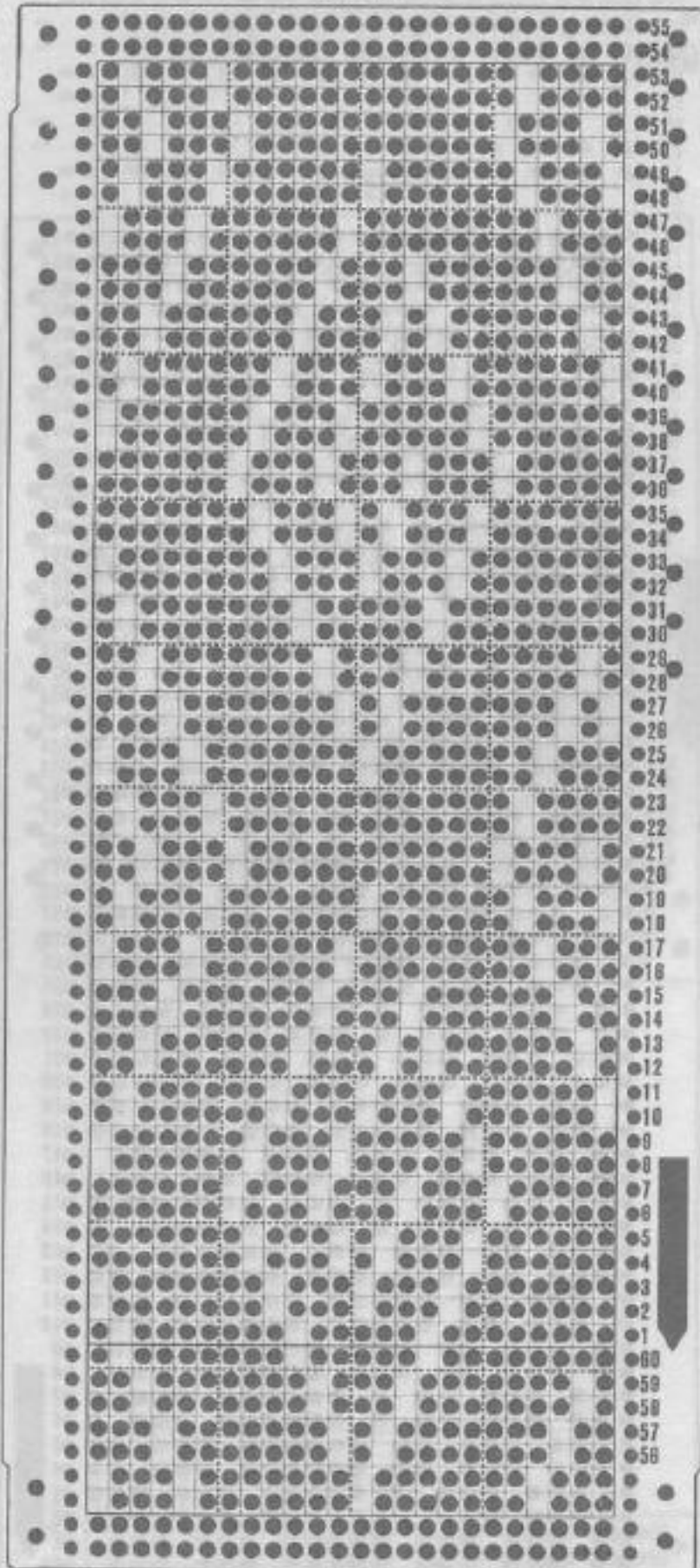


PUNCH CARDS FOR TUCK STITCH PATTERN

*After preparing the pattern knitting, depress both TUCK buttons. In case of two colour tuck stitch pattern, change the yarn in the Yarn feeder A every third row.

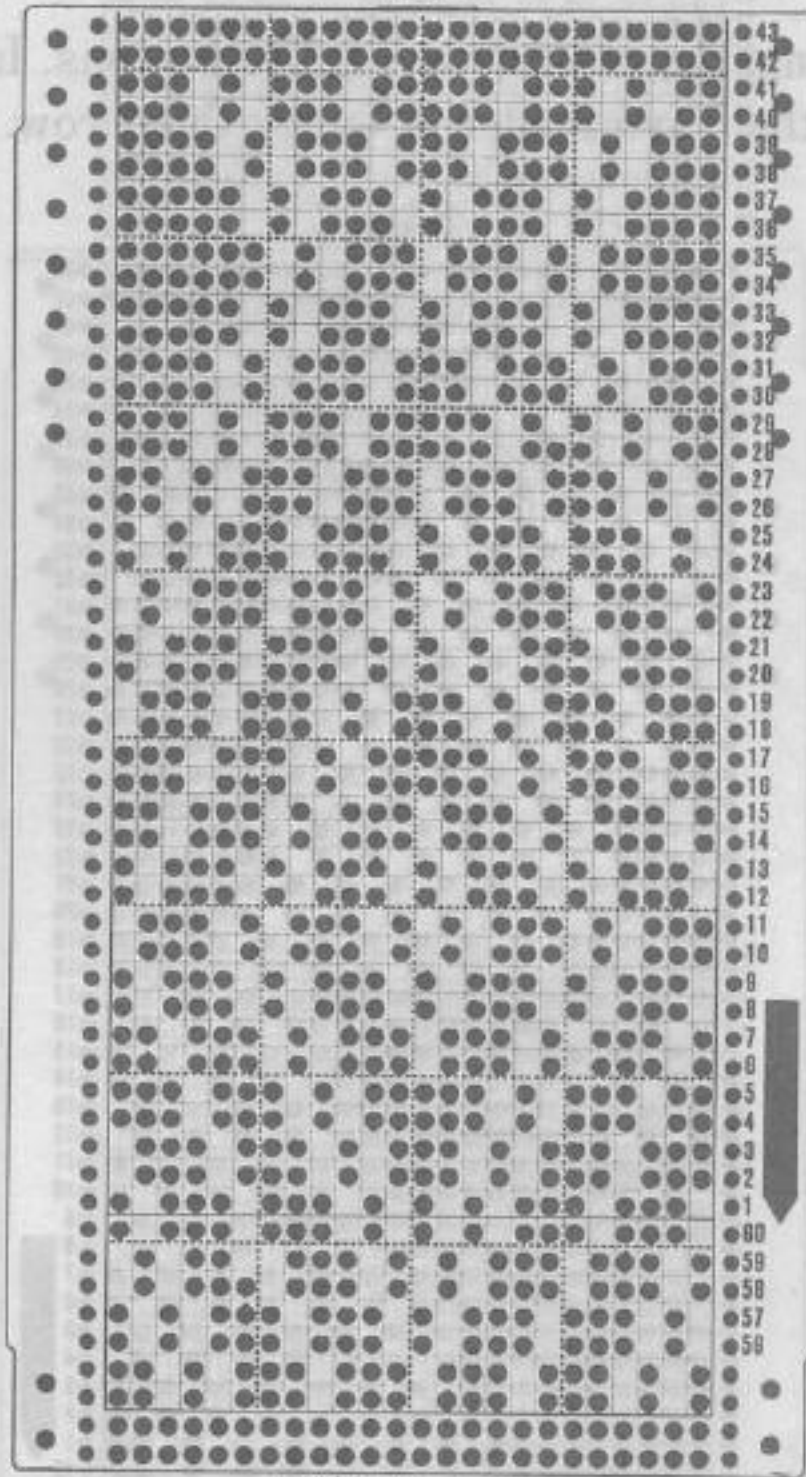


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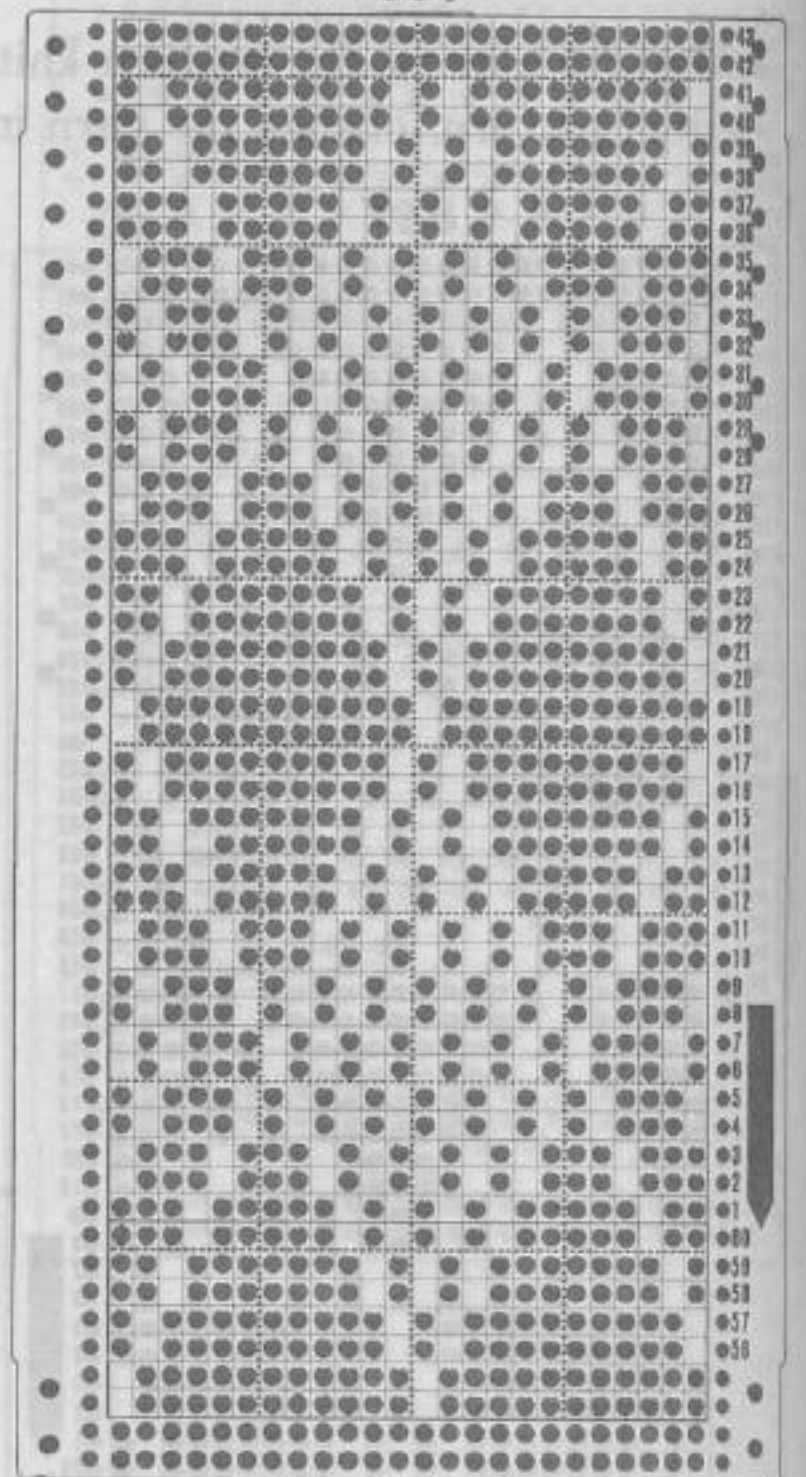

KNITTING SYMBOLS

Symbol & Name	How to Work	Symbol & Name	How to Work
Knit stitch 	Face loop of plain stitch. 	Crossing, right over the left 	Cross the stitches with the right stitch over the left. 
Purl stitch 	Back loop of plain stitch. 	Crossing, right over the right 	Cross the stitches with the left stitch over the right. 
Hole 	Hole made by transferring the stitch to the next needle. 	Cross stitch through left stitch 	Crossed stitches with the right side stitch through the stitch on the left side. 
Two stitches together 	Transfer right stitch to the adjacent left needle. 	Cross stitch through right stitch 	Crossed stitches with the left side stitch through the stitch on the right side. 
Two stitches together 	Transfer left stitch to the adjacent right needle. 	Slip stitch 	A loop marked is pulled up with yarn across behind it. 
Three stitches together 	The center stitch on top of the left and right stitches. 	Float stitch 	A loop marked is pulled up with yarn across in the front. 
Three stitches together 	Right stitch on top. 	Tuck stitch 	A few loops on marked rows pulled up onto one needle. 
Three stitches together 	Left stitch on top. 	Twisted tuck stitch 	A stitch twisted and pulled up onto a needle above. 
Lean stitch to the right 	Lean stitch to the right. 	Twisted stitch 	A stitch is twisted. 
Lean stitch to the left 	Lean stitch to the left. 	Winding stitch 	The loops made by winding the wool around the needles. 
Increased stitch to the right 	Increase one stitch to the left. 	Remarks: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> As a rule, the symbols are used for the right side of the garment. When it especially calls for the wrong side of the garment, the stockinette sts are indicated by marks. Diagram of symbols: In order to represent the structure of the pattern sts the square sections are usually used having each symbol in the center of the section. Sinker loops: In order to represent the sinker loops the symbols are placed inbetween the sections as shown by the figure No. 1, and the row below it in the figure is to line the row below the mark in the diagram of symbols. 	
Increased stitch to the left 	Increase one stitch to the right. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> Woven in wool: The wool in contrasting color woven in the garment is indicated like the figures No. 2. 	
Three stitch increase 	The loops made by winding the wool around the needles.
