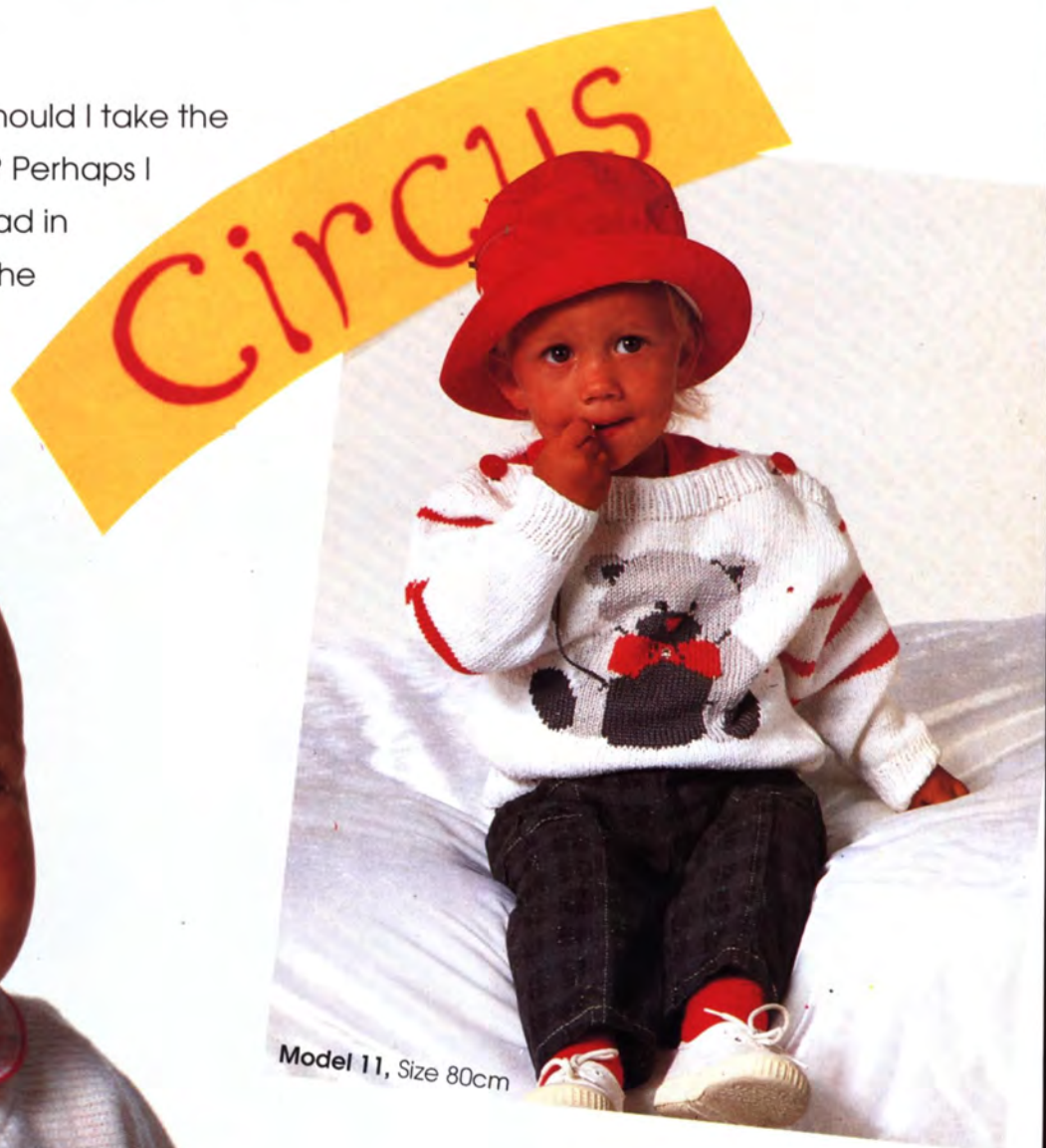


WHITE IS DELICATE

MODEL

SWEATER WITH

ELEPHANT

Size: 122/128cm

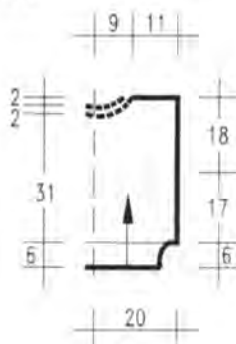
Machines: Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber. We used a Brother KH 930.

Materials: SCHACHENMAYR "Nomotta Regia 4 ply" (75% wool, 25%polyamid, 210m/50g) approx. 150g lt.green, 100g dk.green, 50g each red, brown, lt.grey, yellow and dk.grey. Small amount of white and black. Small amount of white Angora for the cloud.

Tension: 30 sts and 39 R = 10cm.

Wells: 1X1 rib at TD 3.

Intarsia: knitted according to the chart at TD 8.



1/2 front/back

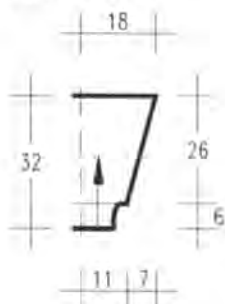
Arrows on pattern denote direction of knitting.

Front: Cast on 102 sts in lt.green and knit 26 R rib. Transfer all sts to MB, increasing to 120 sts. Set RC 000 and knit intarsia, following the chart. At RC 66, mark both edges for armhole. Knit to RC 120 and shape neck. Set carriage to HP and knit as shown on chart, putting needles into HP. Cast off rem. 33 sts at RC 136. Knit 1 R over needles in HP. Transfer sts for rib and knit 10 rows. Cast off loosely.

Back: Cast on and knit as for front, however knit only areas marked 1 and 6. Shape neck, when RC shows 128. Knit neckband as on front.

Sleeves: Cast on 48 sts for 1X1 rib and knit 26 rows. Transfer sts to MB and increase to 68 sts. Set RC 000. Knit in lt.green to RC 70 and then in lt.grey to RC 102. At the same time, shape sides by incr. 1 st at each side on every 5th row 20 times = 108 sts. Cast off at RC 102.

Finishing: Embroider pieces as shown. Large apples only on sleeves. Close shoulder and neckband seams. Set sleeves between markers and close side seams.

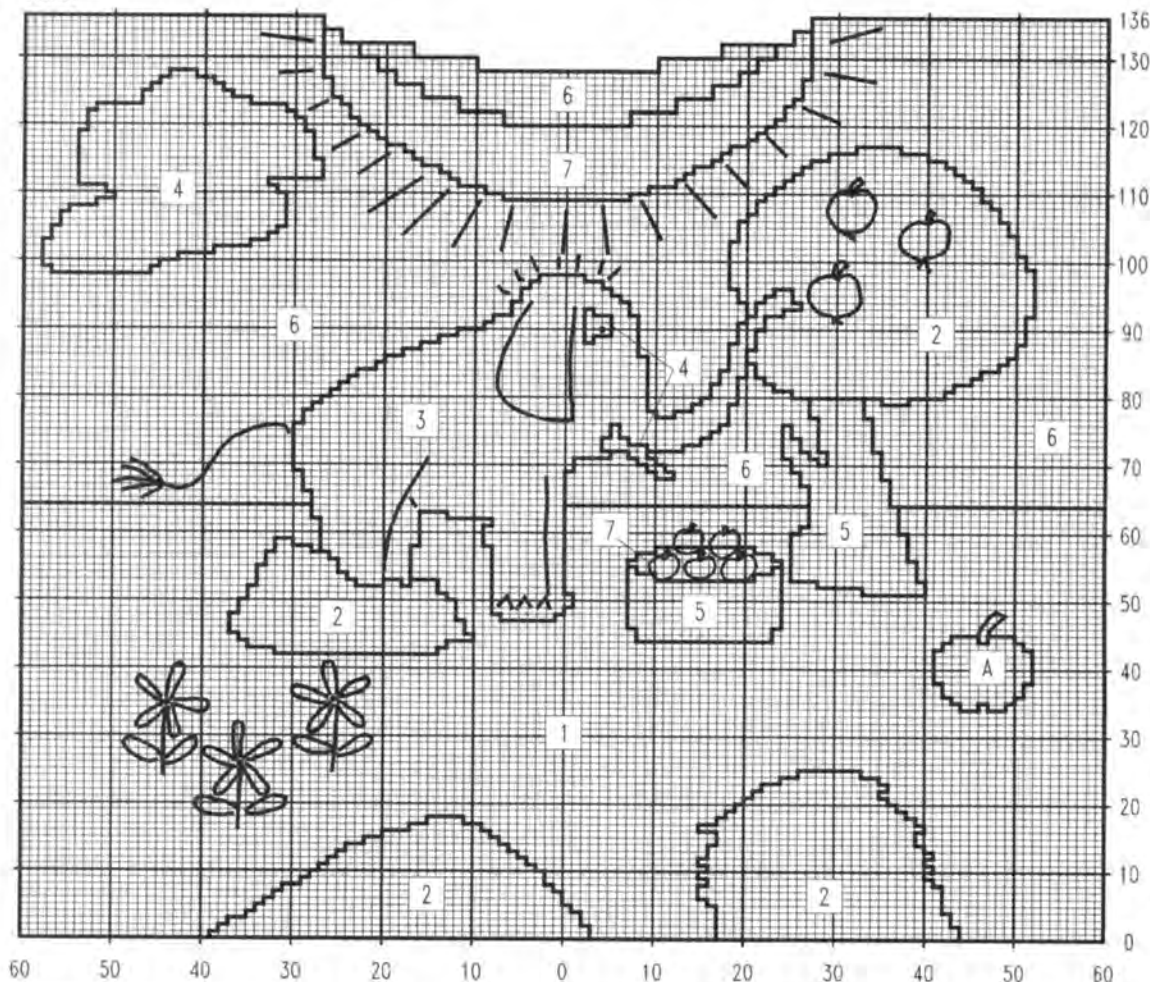
Using the measurements table:

The sizes given in the pattern are heights. You must therefore compare the other measurements in the chart below with those of the child. The backlength is taken from the back of the neck to the required length of the garment. The chest is measured over the widest part below the armholes. The sleeve length is measured from the centre back of neck over the shoulder to the wrist. This will give you 1/2 the back or front width plus the length of the sleeve. Deduct 1/2 the back or front measurement and you will be left with the sleeve length. Compare this with the figures in the table.

Baby sizes:

62cm = 1-3 months
68cm = 3-6 months
72cm = 6-9 months
80cm = 9-12 months

MODEL 2

SWEATER WITH CLOWN

Size: 128/134 (140/146) The instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to both sizes.
Machines: Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber or garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 930 with garter carriage.
Material: SCHACHENMAYR "Rondino" (100% wool, 165m/50g) 250(300)g white, 50g each in turquoise, blue, red and yellow. Small amount of pink for the face. For the embroidery a small amount of black. Crochet hook 3mm, 4 buttons, 1 press stud.
Tension: 26 sts and 33 rows = 10cm at TD 10**.
Ribs: For the garter carriage, use the card for 1 X1 rib or pattern 532 from *Stitch World*. TD approx 8.
Intarsia: Following chart 1 at TD 10**. Cross all threads when changing colour. Place the motif according to the needle arrangement at bottom of chart. Chart 2: These motifs are placed at random on the sleeves in your own arrangement with your own colours.
Arrows on pattern denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 98(108) sts and knit 20 rows rib. Incr. sts to 110(120) and continue in white st st to RC 66 (70). Mark both edges for armhole. Knit to RC 134 (138) and shape neckline. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP the centre 30(34) needles and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows 4 sts once and 3 sts once. When RC shows 140 (144) cast off rem. 33(36) sts. Repeat shaping on other side. For the neckband knit 1 R white over the needles in HP. Knit several rows waste yarn and release work from machine.
Front: Cast on and knit rib as on back. Start intarsia on first row and follow chart. At RC 106(112) cast off stitches 27(29) - 0 - 22(24) for the insert. Knit each side separately, casting off the rem. 33(36) sts. on one side or 28(31) sts on other side when RC shows 140(144).
Sleeves: Cast on in yellow or red 56 (60) sts and knit 20 R rib. Increase to 68 (72) sts and set RC 000. Continue in white, placing motifs at random. At the same time, incr. 1 st at each side on every 4th row 22 times and on every 2nd row twice (on every 6th row 4 times and on every 4th row 20 times) = 116 (120) sts. At RC 94 (110) cast off all sts.
Insert: RC 000. Cast on 26 sts and knit 2 rows in rib. At left edge cast off 2 sts for the neckline. Decr. at left edge on alt. rows 2 sts once and 1 st 4 times = 18 sts. Knit 44 rows straight. At left edge incr. on alt. rows 1 st 4 times and 2 sts twice = 26 sts at RC 56. Knit 4

rows. Make 4 buttonholes at equal distances over 2-3 sts. Knit 4 rows and cast off.
Buttonband: Cast on in yellow 26 sts. Knit 8 rows rib and cast off.
Neckband: With purl side out, hang the 44 (48) sts from the waste yarn on the needles. With buttonholes at left, pick up 54 (58) sts from insert and hang on needles. Knit 11 rows in rib over these 98 (106) needles and cast off with latch tool.
Finishing: Sew the insert to the front. Sew the buttonband to front edge below buttonhole band. Sew on buttons. Close shoulder seams. Finish the clown: embroider the detail in stem stitch. For the bobbles, crochet 3 chains in black or red. Make 3 or 4 half

trebles in first chain, leaving the last loops on the hook. With a slipstitch pull all loops together and fasten off. For the tie cast on 15 sts and knit 4cm in st st. Pick up loops from 1st row to make a hem and cast off. Tie in the centre with a thread. For the hair make a chain approx. 20cm in length. For the second row, make dc's in every stitch taking the yarn around a narrow ruler to from the fringe. Make a second row of loops into the same stitches. Sew around the face. Set in sleeves between markers. Close side and sleeve seams.

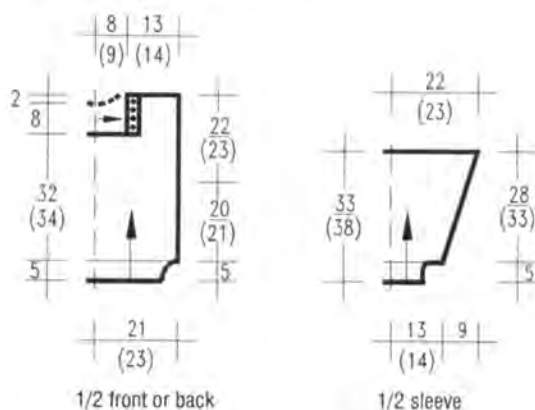

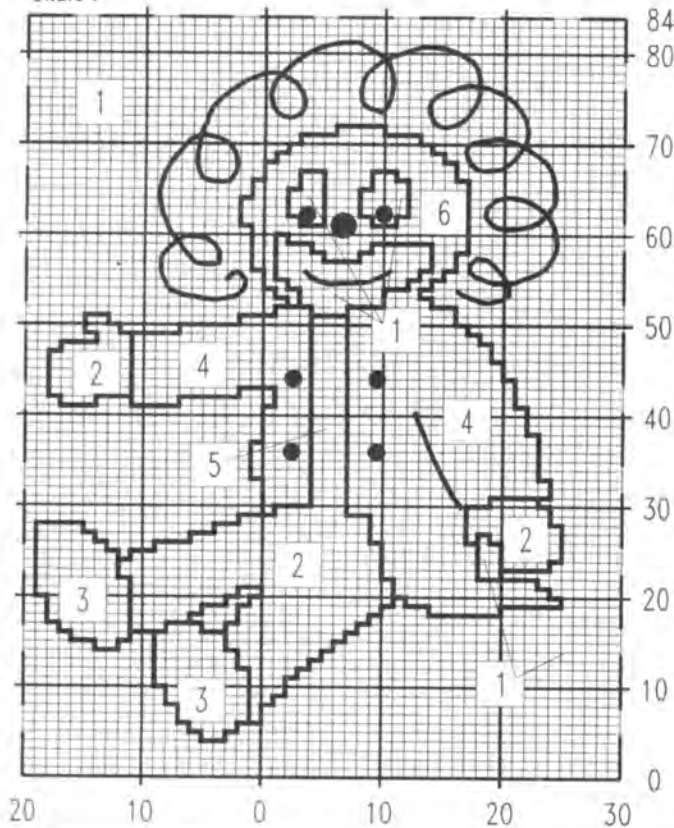
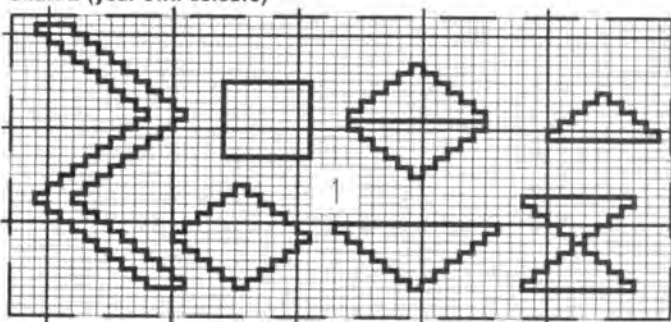


Chart 2 (your own colours)

MODEL 3

SWEATER WITH ELEPHANT AND MOUSE

Size: 140/146cm

Machines: Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber or garter carriage. 24 st machines should substitute a similar fairisle pattern. We used a Brother KH 930.

Material: SCHACHENMAYR "Nomotta Universa" (55% wool, 45% polyacryl, 125m/50g) approx. 300g red, 150g grey and 50g yellow. "Puschka" (50% Mohair, 50% polyacryl, 150m/50g) approx. 50g dk grey and lt grey. A small amount in black and white. 3mm crochet hook.

Tension: 26 sts and 33 R = 10cm in st st on TD 10** 28 sts and 34 R = 10cm over fairisle.

Ribs: 2/2 rib with garter carriage at TD 8. Stitch World pattern 534

Intarsia: knitted following the chart given. Take care to cross threads to avoid holes. Smaller areas may be swiss-darned. The outlines are embroidered in black stemstitch. For the tails, crochet short chains in the correct shade of grey and sew on.

Fairisle: For electronic machines, mark the mylar sheet or enter the program. For 24 st machines, use a similar punchcard. Repeat the pattern in the height.

Arrows on diagram denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 110 sts and knit 20 rows rib. Set RC 000 and continue in red to RC 72. Mark both edges for the arm-hole. At RC 130, shape the neck. Set carriage to HOLD. Push to HP the centre 30 sts and all needles at side opposite to carriage. Knit each side separately, putting to HP at neck edge on alt. rows 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once. Cast off rem. 36 sts at RC 138. Repeat for other side.

Neckband: Knit 1 row over all needles in HP in red. Change to rib and knit 9 rows. Knit last row on loosest TD setting and cast off with latch tool.

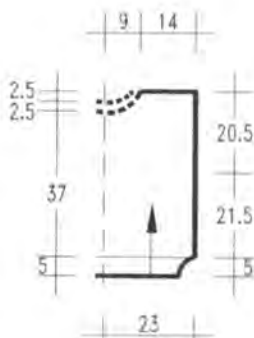
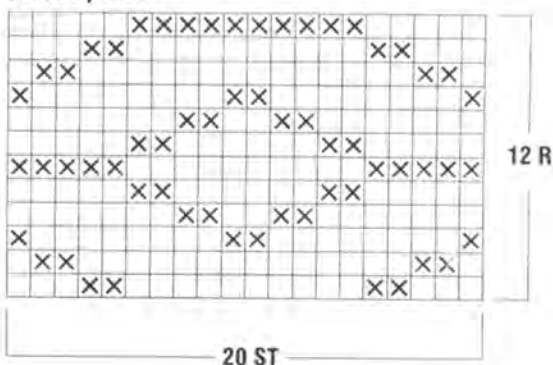
Front: Cast on and knit rib as for back. Set RC 000 and knit 5 rows. Start intarsia and knit till RC 122. Shape neck by putting centre 14 sts to HP. Knit each side separately, putting to HP at neck edge on alt rows 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts 5 times. Cast off rem. 36 sts at RC 138. Repeat for other side. Knit neckband as for back.

Sleeves: Close shoulder and neckband seams. With purl side facing, pick up 116 sts between markers on side edge. Set RC 000 and knit in fairisle pattern, decr. 1 st at each side on every 4th row 25 times = 66 sts. At RC 102, reduce sts to 50. Knit 1 row st st and change to rib knitting. Knit 20 rows and cast off.

Finishing: Embroider on front as described. Close rem. seams.

Fairisle pattern

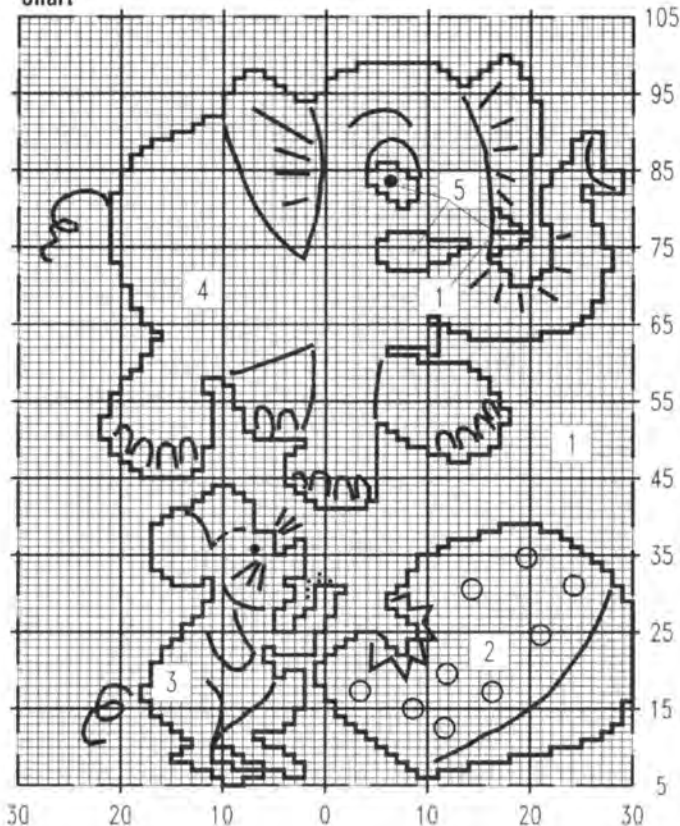

MODEL 4

SWEATER WITH FLYING PIG

Size: 116/122cm
Machines: Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber or garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 930 with garter carriage.
Material: JUNGHANS "Holiday" (40% cotton, 40% wool, 150m/50g) approx. 250g blue, 100g white, 50g yellow. Small amount pink Angora for the pig, black and lt. green for the embroidery. 3mm crochet hook.
Tension: 25-26 sts and 35-36 rows = 10cm. TD approx. 10**.
Ribs: 1/1 rib at TD approx. 8. The ribs are started with blue and knitted in stripes of 2 rows each blue and white.
Intarsia: Knitted following the chart. Smaller areas can also be swiss-darned.
Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

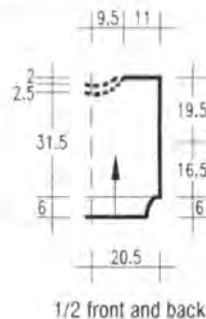
Back: Cast on 100 sts and knit 20 R rib. Increase to 106 sts and continue in st st. At **RC 58** mark both edges for armhole. At **RC 120** shape neck. Set carriage for HP and put centre 26 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage to HP. On first side push to HP on alt. rows at neck edge 6 sts once and 3 sts twice. At **RC 128** cast off rem. 28 sts. Repeat for other side.

Neckband: Knit 1 row in blue over the 50 sts in HP. Arrange for rib and knit 7 rows white and 2 rows blue. Knit the last row as loose as possible and cast off with latch tool.

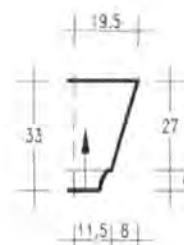
Front: Cast on and knit rib as for back. Knit in st st to **RC 23** and work intarsia from the chart. Knit neckline starting on **RC 113** as shown on chart. Knit the neckband as on back.

Sleeves: Cast on 50 sts and knit rib as on back. Change to st st and incr. 10 sts evenly across the row. Set **RC 000**. Continue in blue st st, adding the white clouds shown as "6" on chart at random. Shape the sides by incr. 1 st st each side on every 6th row 5 times and on every 4th row 15 times = 100 sts. Knit to **RC 96** and cast off.

Finishing: Embroider the front. For the tail, crochet a chain in pink of 16 sts. Crochet 2 dc's in each chain to produce the curl. Crochet two stars using

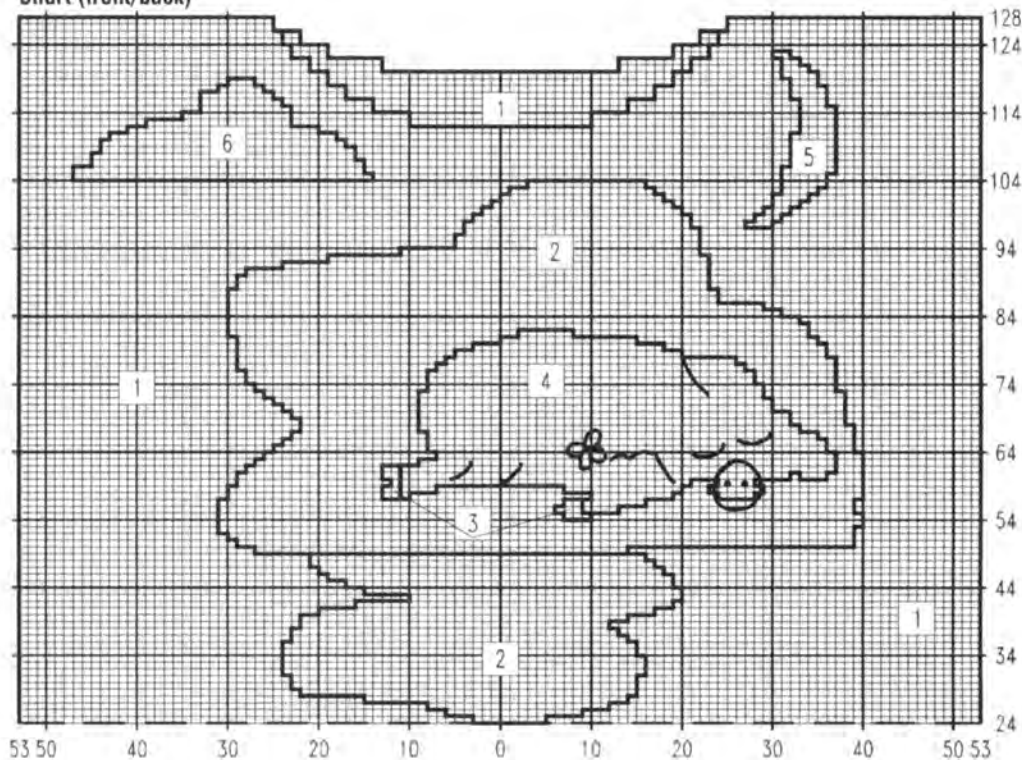

the crochet chart. For the clover leaf make 3 chains. 2nd row: * 2 chains, 1 dc in the chain. Repeat from * 3 times. Fasten off. Close shoulder and neck band seams. Set sleeves between markers. Close rem. seams.

 4 = pink

MODEL 5

SWEATER WITH CATS

Size: 134/140cm

Machines: Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber or garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 930 with garter carriage.

Material: SCHACHENMAYR "Bagnola" (100% mercerised cotton, 180m/50g) approx. 250g white, 100g yellow, 50g blue, small amount black. Drop beads for the shower, 4 buttons, 2.5mm crochet hook.

Tension: 32 sts and 40 R = 10cm, TD approx. 7.

Ribs: 1/1 rib at TD approx. 4. Stitch World pattern 532.

Garter stitch: Knitted over 2 rows in blue. Use Stitch World pattern 537 or punchcard. Could also be knitted by transferring all sts to RB for 1 row and then transferring back to MB.

Fairisle: Use Stitch World pattern 547 or punch a card according to the diagram, repeating the design once in width and once in height.

Intarsia: Follow the chart given, using TD approx. 7.

Embroidery: Enlarge the design and embroider in stemstitch in black. Embroider along bath and over the window. Embroider water drops in blue lazy-daisy stitch.

Back: Cast on in yellow 126 sts and knit 25 R rib. Change to fairisle and knit 32 rows in yellow and white. Continue in white st st. At RC 76 mark both edges for armholes. At RC 156 shape neck. Push to HP the centre 36 sts and knit each side separately. At neck edge push to HP on alt, rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once and 3 sts once. Cast off rem. 43 sts at RC 164. Repeat for other side.

Neckband: Knit 1 row white over sts in HP. Knit several rows waste yarn and release from machine.

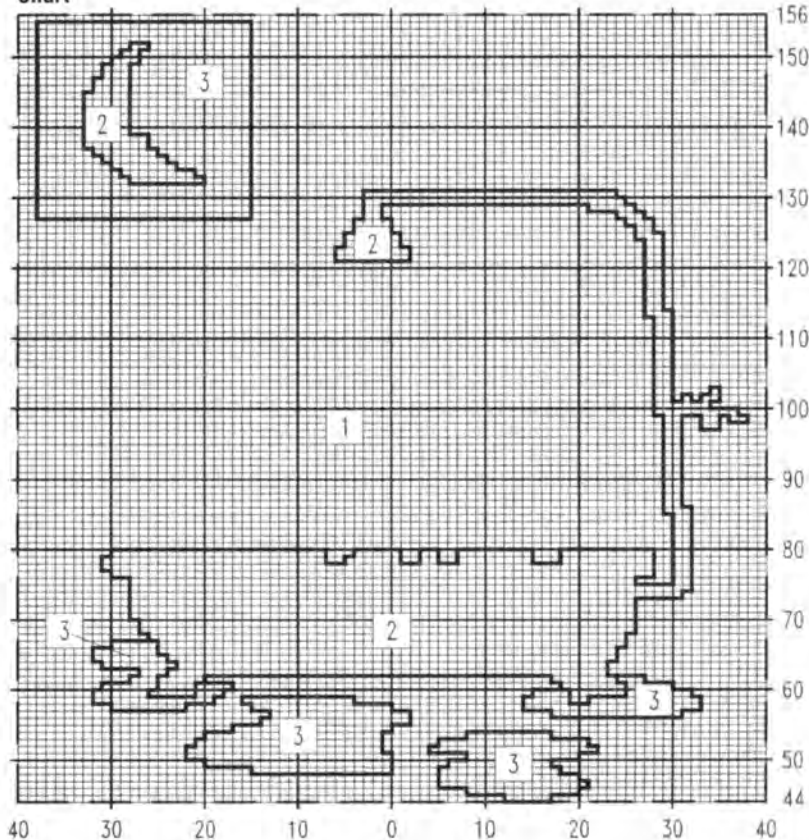
Front: Cast on and knit as for back till RC 44. Start intarsia and knit to RC 155. Shape neck as on back.

Neckband: Hang sts from waste yarn on back next to sts in HP on front. Knit 12 rows rib over all 120 sts and cast off with latch tool.

Sleeves: Cast on in yellow 66 sts and knit 25 rows rib. Increase to 84 sts and knit 2 rows yellow. Knit 32 rows in fairisle. * Knit 18 rows white, 2 rows garter stitch in blue. Repeat from * to the end. At the same time, increase 1 st at each side on every 4th row 28 times = 140 sts. Cast off at RC 122.

Finishing: Close left shoulder seam. Crochet along right shoulder 2 rows of dc. At front edge make 4 buttonholes with 5-6 chains each. Sew buttons to backedge and fasten. Embroider the cats. Set sleeves between markers. Close rem. seams.

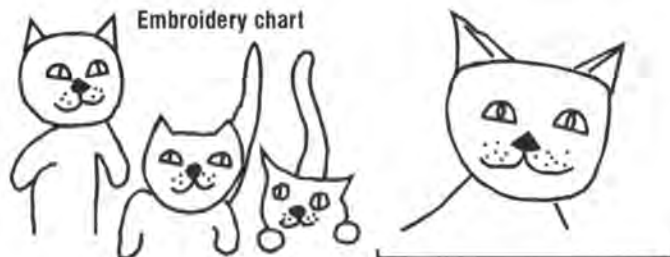

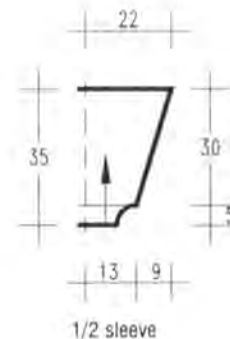

MODEL 6

ORIENTAL BABY JACKET

Size: 68/74cm

Machines: Suitable for chunky machines with intarsia carriage. We used a Brother KH 260.

Material: WSM "Filini" (100% merino wool, 160m/50g) approx. 150g pink, 50g each in lilac, green and fuchsia. Small amounts of viscose yarn in green and green/lilac flecked. Lurex in silver and lilac. Black wool. 5 buttons. 2.5mm knitting needles for welts and bands.

Available as a kit from E&S STRICK-STUDIO, Zinngießergasse 9, 8015 Markt Schaben. Tel.:(010 49) 8121 5302. Send Eurocheque for DM 84,20.

Tension: 22 sts and 34 R = 10cm. TD approx. 0.

Ribs: Knitted by hand as k1, pl rib.

Intarsia: Knitted from the chart. Read all increases and decreases from the chart. Smaller areas can be swiss-darned.

Arrows on pattern denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 70 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit following chart 1.

Right front: Cast on 35 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Change to main yarn and knit according to chart 2.

Left front: Knit as for right front, using chart 3.

Sleeves: Cast on 50 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Change to main yarn and knit in st st in pink. Increase 1 st at each side every 5th row 7 times = 64 sts. At RC 40, shape top. Cast off at each side on alt. rows 5 sts once and 2 sts once. Knit straight to RC 70. Cast off at each side on alt. rows 1 st twice, 3 sts twice, 4 sts once and 5 sts once. Cast off rem. 16 sts at RC 84.

Cuffs: Pick up sts from bottom of sleeves and knit 5cm in kl, pl rib, using pink. Cast off.

Finishing: Close all seams. Set in sleeves, gathering the top to fit. For the **neckband**, pick up 68 sts from neck edge knit 3cm in stocking stitch. Cast off. Fold in half to inside and slipstitch in position. Pick up 140 sts from **lower edge of jacket** and knit 5cm in st st. Cast off and fold to inside. Sew down. For **button bands** pick up 62 sts and knit 4 cm st st. Fold in and sew down. For **buttonhole band** pick up as before.

Make 5 buttonholes after 1cm and 3 cm width by casting off 3 sts on one row and casting on again on the return row. Stitch around the buttonholes to finish. Sew on buttons.

MODEL 7

PURPLE SWEATER WITH TEDDY

Size: 62/68 (122/128) The instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to both size.

Machines: Suitable for chunky machines with intarsia carriage. Ribs are knitted by hand. We used a Brother KH 260.

Material: WSM "Filini" (100% mercerised cotton, 160m/50g) approx. 150 (300)g purple. Small amounts of shiny yarn in turquoise and lilac. Angora in grey. Lurex in purple. 2(4) press studs. 2 black beads for the eyes. 1 turquoise bead for teddy's bow. 3mm knitting needles.

Available as complete package from E&S STRICKSTUDIO, Zinngießergasse 9, 8015 Markt Schaben. Tel.:(010 49) 8121 5302. Send Eurocheque for DM 56,10 (84,20).

The sweater is worn with a white T-shirt with lace collar. Lace collars are available at haberdashery shops.

Tension: 22 sts and 34 R = 10cm at TD approx. 0.

Ribs: Knitted by hand as kl, pl rib.

Intarsia: Knitted from the chart. Small areas may be swiss-darned. The chart shows the centre 50 sts only. Continue the diagonal stripes on both sides to the edge of the garment.

Back: Cast on in waste yarn 56 (86) sts and knit several rows. Change to purple and knit in st st. to **RC 44 (54)**. Shape armholes by casting off 5 (6) sts at beg. of next 2 rows. Decr. at both sides on alt. rows 2 sts once (twice) and 1 st 3 (4) times = **36 (58) sts**. Knit straight to **RC 70 (92)** and shape neck. Push to HP the centre 6 (12) sts and knit each side separately. At neck edge decr. on alt. rows 4 (7) sts once, 3 sts twice and 2 sts once. 3 (8) sts remain at **RC 80 (102)**. After knitting the second side, knit 12 rows purple over the **36 (58) sts** in HP and cast off. Fold band in half to inside and sew down.

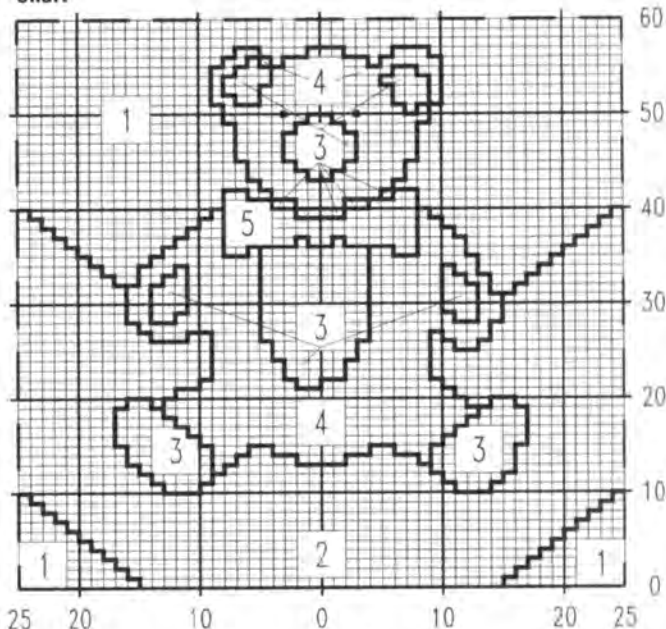

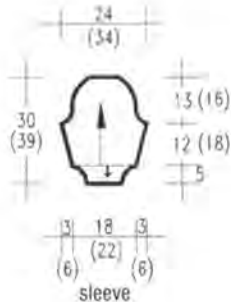
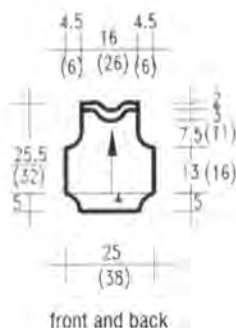

follow instructions below.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

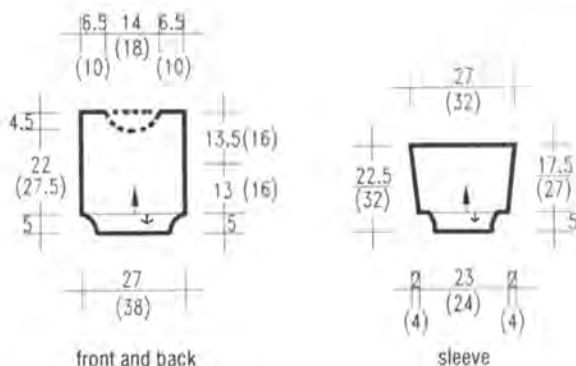
Back: Cast on **60 (84) sts** with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit in black st st. At **RC 44 (54)** mark both edges for the armholes. 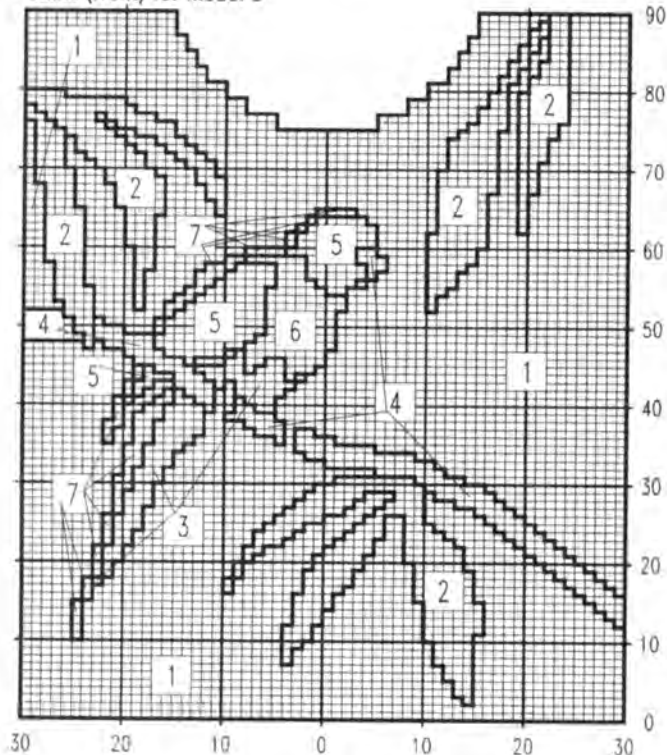

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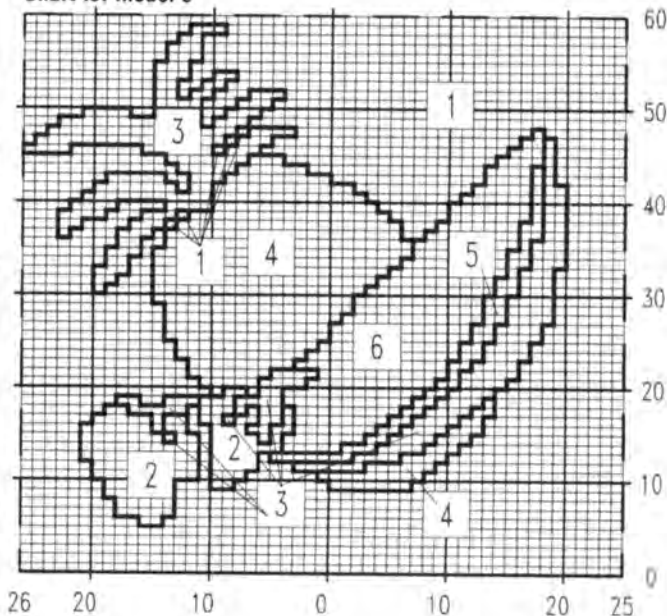
Chart (front) for model 8

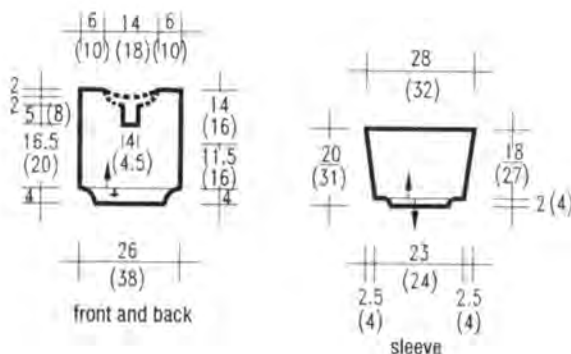

On right side knit straight to RC 73 (95). At left edge push to HP for the neck on alt. rows 2 (3) sts once, 2 sts 3 (4) times and 1 st 3 times. Cast off rem. 13 (22) sts at RC 88 (112). Knit **neckband** as described for back. Knit left side, reversing all shapings.

Sleeves: Cast on 50 (52) sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit in st st: 31 (41) rows white, 2 (4) rows red, 5 (8) rows white, 2 (4) rows green, 5 (8) rows white, 2 (4) rows red, 13 (23) rows white = 60 (92) rows. At the same time, increase 1 st at each side on every 10th row 5 (9) times = 60 (70) sts. At RC 60 (92) cast off all sts.

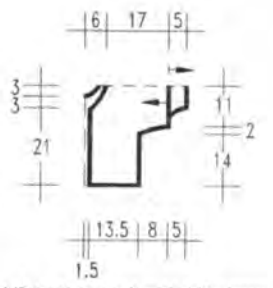

Arrows on diagram denote direction of knitting.
Cast on 70 sts with waste yarn in centre of bed. Knit several rows. Set RC 000 and change to main yarn. Work intarsia from the chart and also increase at both edges as shown. At **RC 34 and 35**, cast on the additional sts by E-wrap. At **RC 75**, cast off the centre 4 sts and knit each side separately. Knit the right side (back) first. At **RC 100**, read the chart from top to bottom till you reach the end of the neckshaping. Push the needles to HP. Return needles at left to WP and continue to knit the front. At **RC 94**, cast off. Cast on by E-wrap over the same 67 needles and knit the other front, reading the chart from top to bottom and increasing as shown. 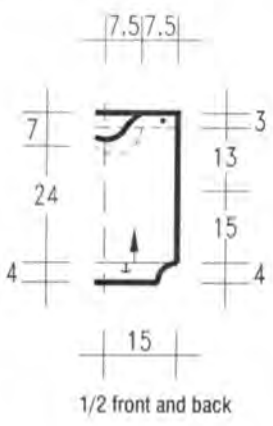

Intarsia: Knitted following the chart. Smaller areas may also be swiss-darned.
Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.
Back: Cast on 80 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit in white st st to **RC 51**. Mark both side edges. At **RC 96**, change to rib knitting and knit 12 rows. Cast off.
Front: Cast on 80 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit intarsia, following the chart. At **RC 51**, mark both side edges for the armhole. At **RC 84**, shape the neck according to the chart, putting the needles to HP. Knit each side separately. Both sides finish at **RC 96**. Knit 1 row over 80 sts in HP. Change to rib knitting and knit the band as for back, making a buttonhole at each side 10 sts in on row 6.

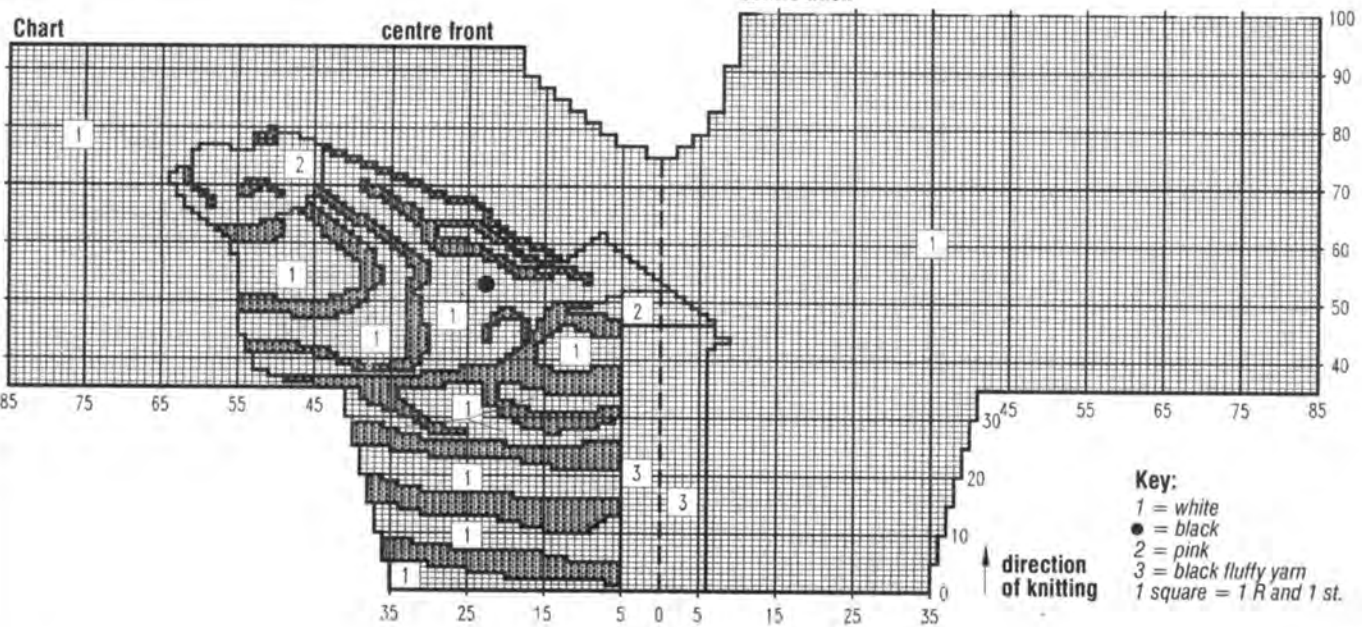

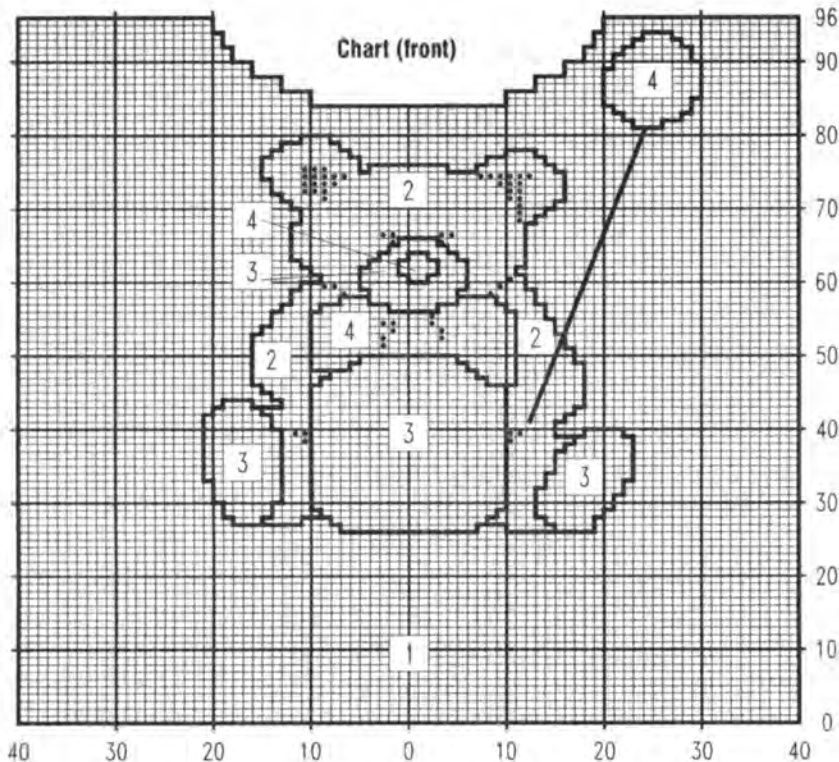

Tension: Front and back: 25 sts and 35 R = 10cm. at TD 10. Sleeves: 25 sts and 35 R = 10cm at TD 9* over garterstitch pattern.

Ribs: Knitted with garter carriage 1/1 rib at TD approx. 5.

Intarsia: Knitted following the chart. Small areas may be swiss-darned. The outlines are embroidered in black stemstitch.

Garterstitch pattern: Mark mylar sheet or program machine as shown. The pattern is used over all sts on the sleeves. On the front work 4 single motifs only.

Stripe sequence: 4 R white, 2 R pink, 4 R white, 2 R blue, 4 R white, 2 R green and 4 R white = 22 rows.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Back: E-wrap cast on 94 sts and with garter carriage knit 22 rows rib in stripe sequence. Take off machine and replace, incr. to 110 sts. Set RC 000 and knit to RC 63. Mark both side edges. Knit to RC 120 and shape neck. Set carriage for HP and push to HP the centre 18 sts and all sts at side oppo-

site to carriage. Knit each side separately. Push to HP at neck edge on alt. rows 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once. Cast off the rem. 37 sts at RC 128. Repeat for other side. Knit 1 row over sts in HP. Arrange for rib and knit 2 rows green, 2 rows white, 2 rows blue, 2 rows white, 2 rows pink and 1 row white. Cast off loosely.

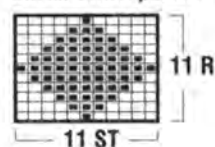

Cuffs: Cast on in 1/1 rib 52(56) sts in black and knit 36 rows rib. Attach to lower edge of sleeves as described for front and back.

Finishing: Close shoulder seams for 18(19)cm at each side, set in sleeves between markers. Close rem. seams. Sew on button and glass beads.

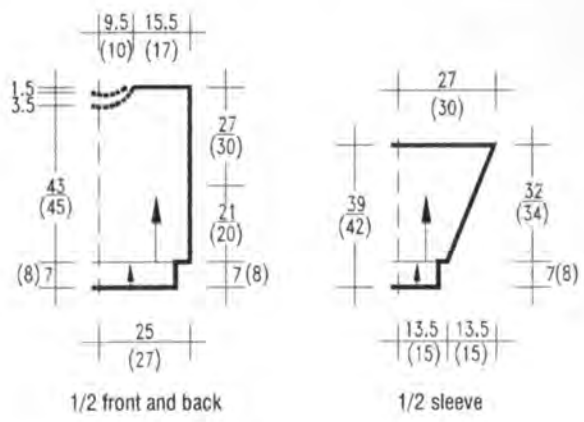

Left sleeve: Knit as above, using chart 3.



Welts: With red and with RB in position, cast on 120 sts in 1/1 rib and knit 36 rows. Transfer all sts to MB. Pick up sts from edges of back or front and hang on needles, dec. as necessary. Knit 1 row and cast off.

Cuffs: Knit as above over 66 sts.

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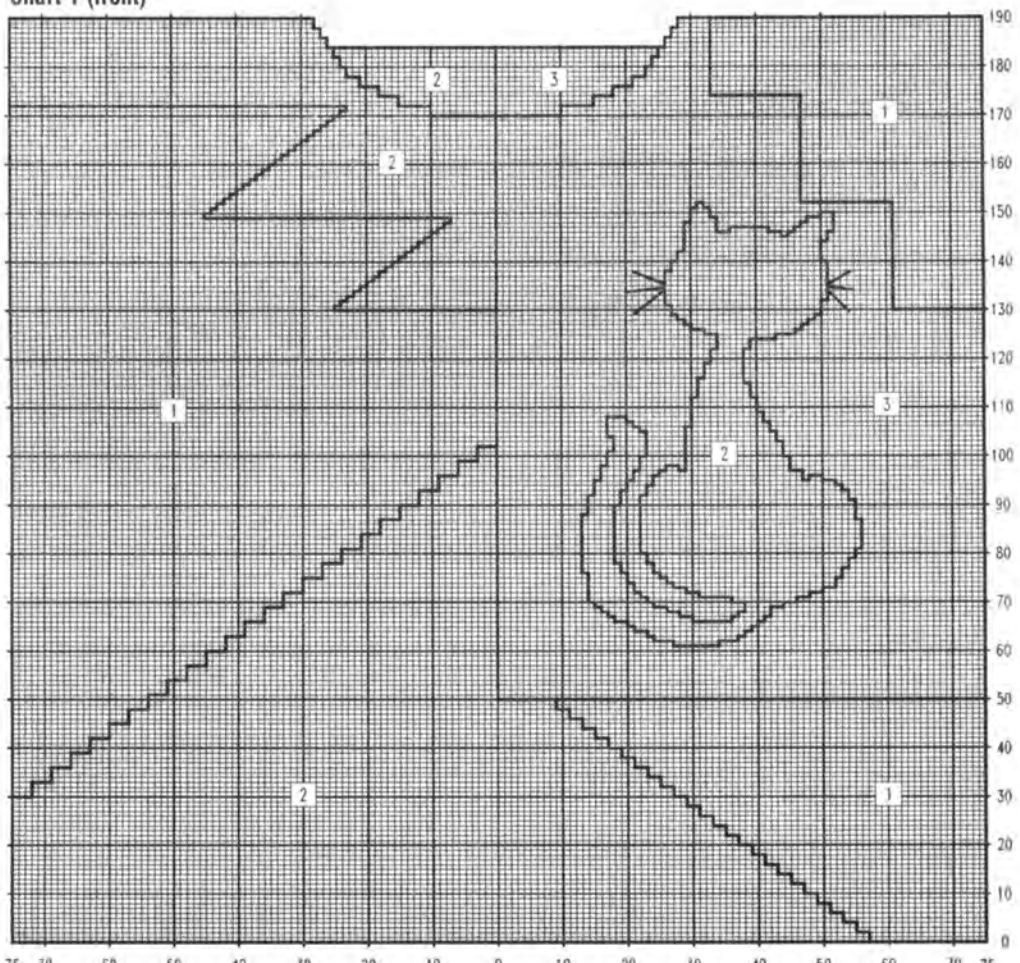

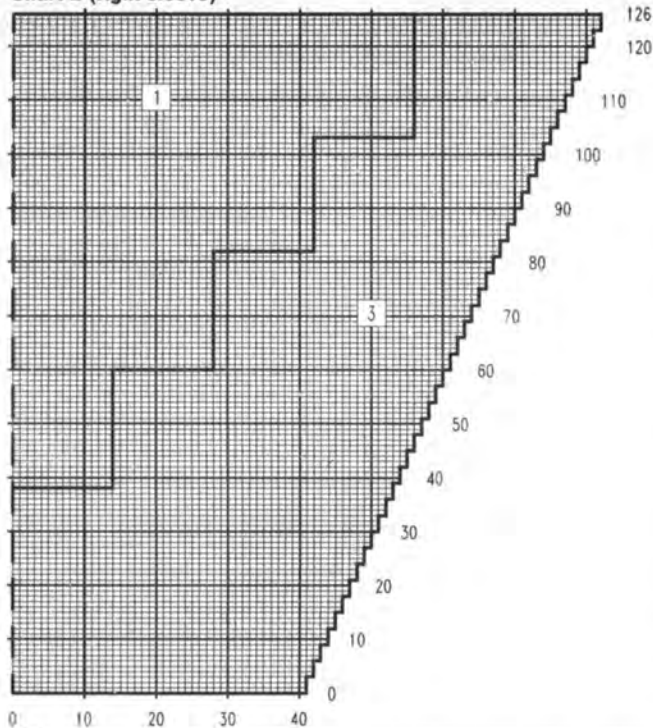
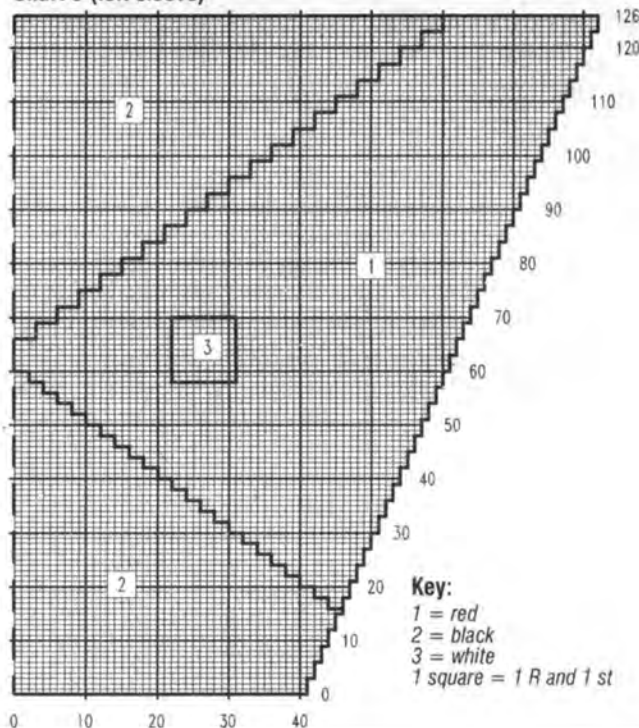

Tension: 29 sts and 39 R = 10cm over st st Filini. TD approx. 8.

Ribs: 1/1 rib at TD approx. 4.

Intarsia: Using the chart, knit at TD 8 with separate balls of yarn for each colour. Smaller areas may be swiss-darned. Stitches marked A and B are cabled as follows: Cable A over 6 sts. Move 3 sts at right to the left and 3 sts at left to the right. Cable B over 6 sts. Move 3 sts at left to the right and 3 sts

at right to the left. Take care to open the latches after cabling, before knitting intarsia again.

Arrows on diagram denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 156 sts in Filini royal and knit 54 rows in 1/1 rib. Transfer all sts to MB. Set RC 000 and continue in st st to **RC 104**. Mark both edges for armholes. Knit straight to **RC 218**. Knit 1 row at TD. 10. Knit 19 rows at TD. 8. Pick up loops from loose row and hang on needles. Cast off.

Front: Cast on and knit rib as on back. Transfer all sts to MB. Set RC 000 and work from chart in intarsia. Mark both edges at **RC 104**. At **RC 194**, shape neck. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 20 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. Knit each side separately, pushing to HP at neck edge on

alt. rows 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 8 times. Do not cast off rem. shoulder sts, but after knitting the second side, return all needles to WP. Knit neckband as for back over all sts.

Sleeves: Close shoulder seams. With purl side facing you, pick up 188 sts between markers on side edges. With Filini royal knit in stocking stitch, decreasing at each side 1 st on every 2nd row 20 times and on every 3rd row 30 times = 88 sts. At **RC 136**, decrease to 50 sts and knit 1 row. Transfer sts for rib. Knit 35 rows and cast off with latch tool.

Finishing: Embroider the broom in black stemstitch and sew on the beads. Close side and sleeve seams.

Tip:

To keep Mohair and Angora sweaters in good condition, wash them in egg shampoo. When they are dry, put them in a plastic bag in the freezer for 2 hours. Bring them out to thaw gently till they are dry.

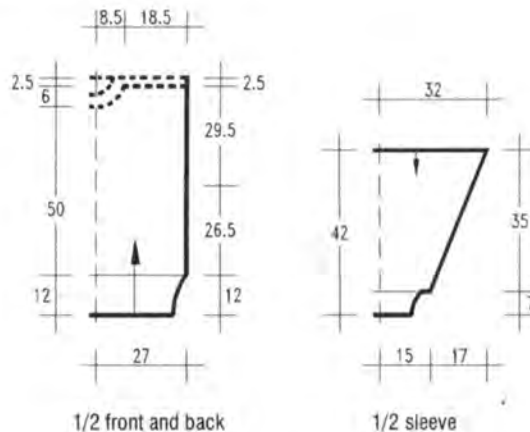
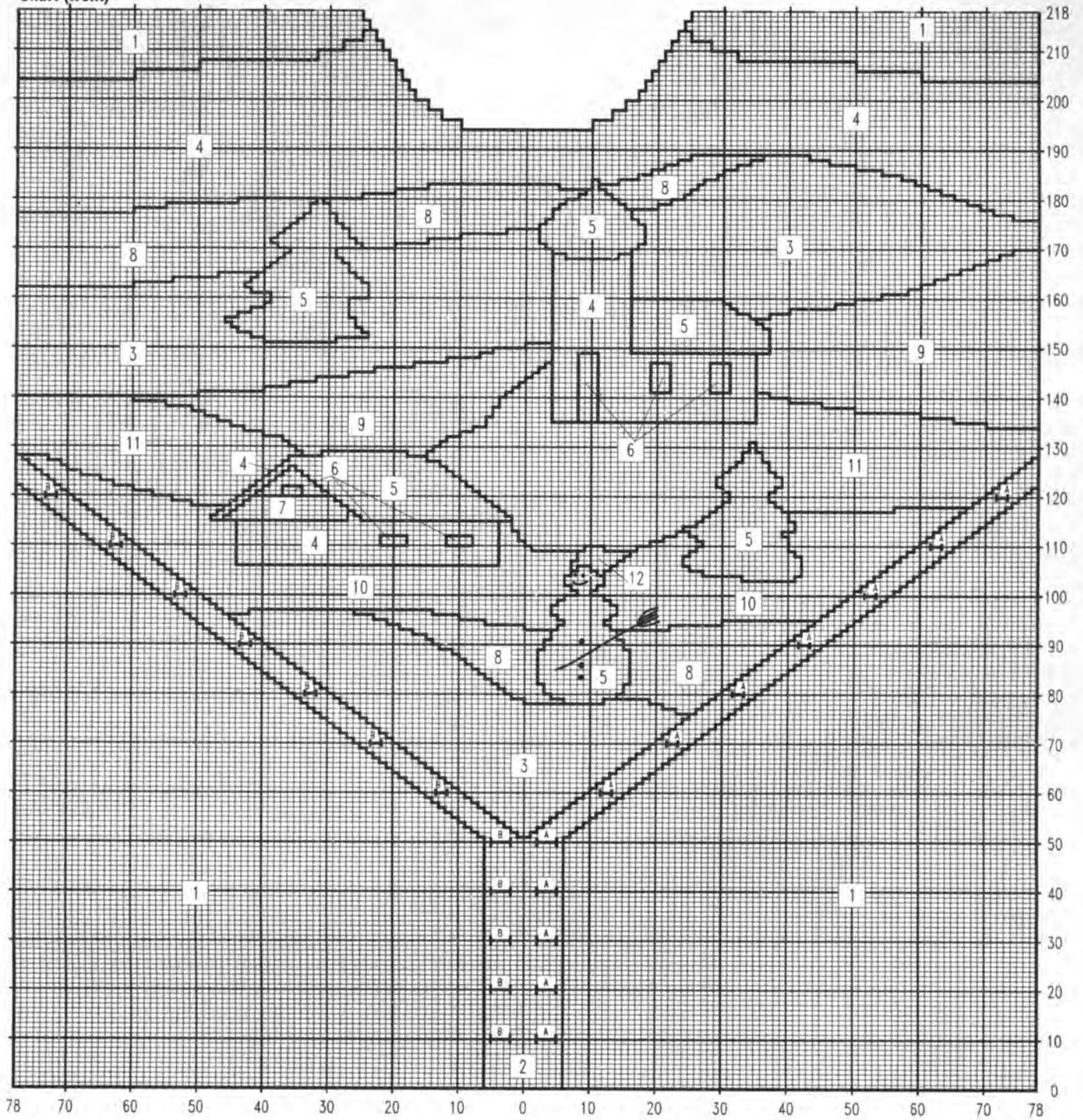

Material: PINGOUIN "Corrida" (60% cotton, 40% polyacryl, 210m/50g) approx. 250g lt.blue, 50g each red, green and yellow. 7 buttons. 3mm crochet hook.

Tension: 30 sts and 38 rows = 10cm at TD approx. 8.

Ribs: 1/1 rib on garter carriage at TD approx. 5.

Fairisle pattern: Program the machine or punch a card to suit your machine. The various symbols show the colours

to be used. The single motif is too large for a punchcard, but can be swiss-darned after knitting. Alternately select the needles by hand prior to knitting each row or substitute a smaller design.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Back: In lt.blue cast on and knit 24 rows in rib. Set RC 000 and knit 20 rows st st. Knit 54 rows in fairisle and then continue in lt.blue st st. At **RC 98**, mark both edges for armhole. At **RC 152**, cast off centre 40 sts and knit each side separately. Cast off at neckline on alt. rows 2 sts once and 1 st twice. cast off rem. 41 sts at **RC 162**.

Right front: In lt.blue cast on 65 sts and knit as on back, marking the right edge on **RC 98**. At **RC 141**, cast off at left edge 14 sts for the neck. Decr. at left edge on foll. alt. rows 3 sts once, 2 sts twice and 1 st 3 times. Cast off rem. 41 sts at **RC 162**.

Left front: Knit as for right front, reversing all shapings and including the single motif at **RC 94**.

Sleeves: Cast on 50 sts in lt.blue and knit 24 rows in rib. Set RC 000 and knit

pattern as for back. At the same time, incr. 1 st at each side on every 5th row 13 times and on every 4th row 13 times = 102 sts. At **RC 120**, cast off.

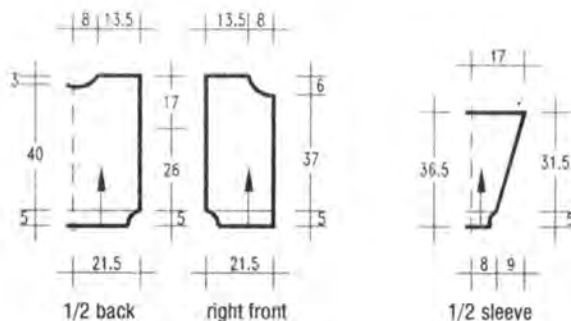

Ribs: 1/1 rib knitted by hand.

Intarsia: Knitted from the chart, using separate balls of yarn for each colour.

Arrows on diagram denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 80(88) sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set **RC 000** and knit in red st st to **RC 64(72)**. Mark both edges for armholes. Knit to **RC**

Neckband: Close one shoulder seam. Pick up sts from waste yarn and put on knitting needle. **72(80) sts**. Knit in 1/1 rib 6 rows red, 2 rows olive. Cast off loosely. Close second shoulder seam and neckband seam.

Sleeves: With waste yarn cast on 44(46) sts and knit several rows. Set **RC 000** and knit in red st st, increasing 1 st at each side on every 6th row 14(15) times = **72(76) sts**. At **RC 86(96)** cast off all sts.

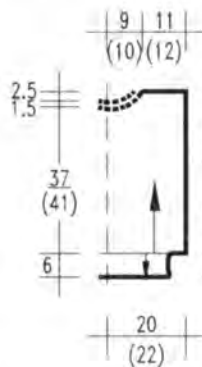

Sleeves: Cast on in turquoise 50 sts and knit 18 rows rib in stripe sequence. Set RC 000 and incr. 18 sts evenly across the row = 68 sts. Continue in turquoise to RC 72, incr. 1 st at each side on every 5th row 17 times and on every 4th row twice. From RC 72, knit 6 rows each in red, green, yellow and turquoise. At RC 96, cast off all sts.

Finishing: Embroider the front with black - see photo. Make bobbles: Make 3 chains, make 6 half trebles in first

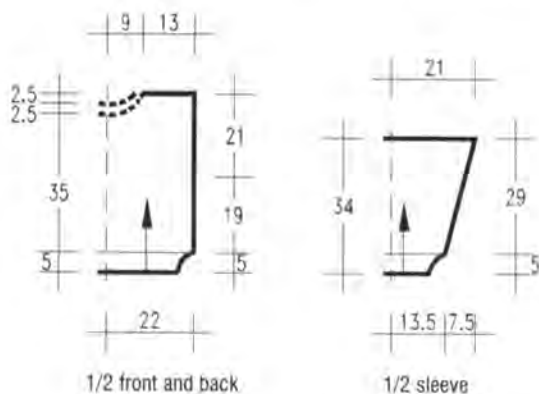

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 130(132) sts by E-wrap and knit 30 rib. Set RC 000 and continue in pattern. At RC 99(117) mark both edges for armholes. At RC 200(229) cast off all stitches.

Front: Knit as for back to RC 126(140). Divide work for V-neck and knit each side separately. At neck edge cast off 1 st on every 4th row 17(20) times. Cast off rem. 43(46) sts at RC 200(229).

Sleeves: Close shoulder seams. With purl side out, pick up 126(138) sts from one edge between markers. Knit 1 row st st. RC 000. Put switch 5 UP

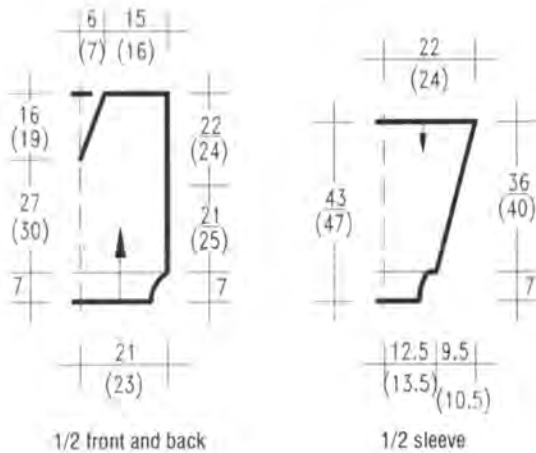
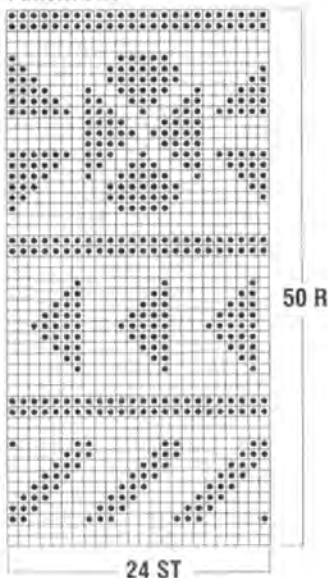

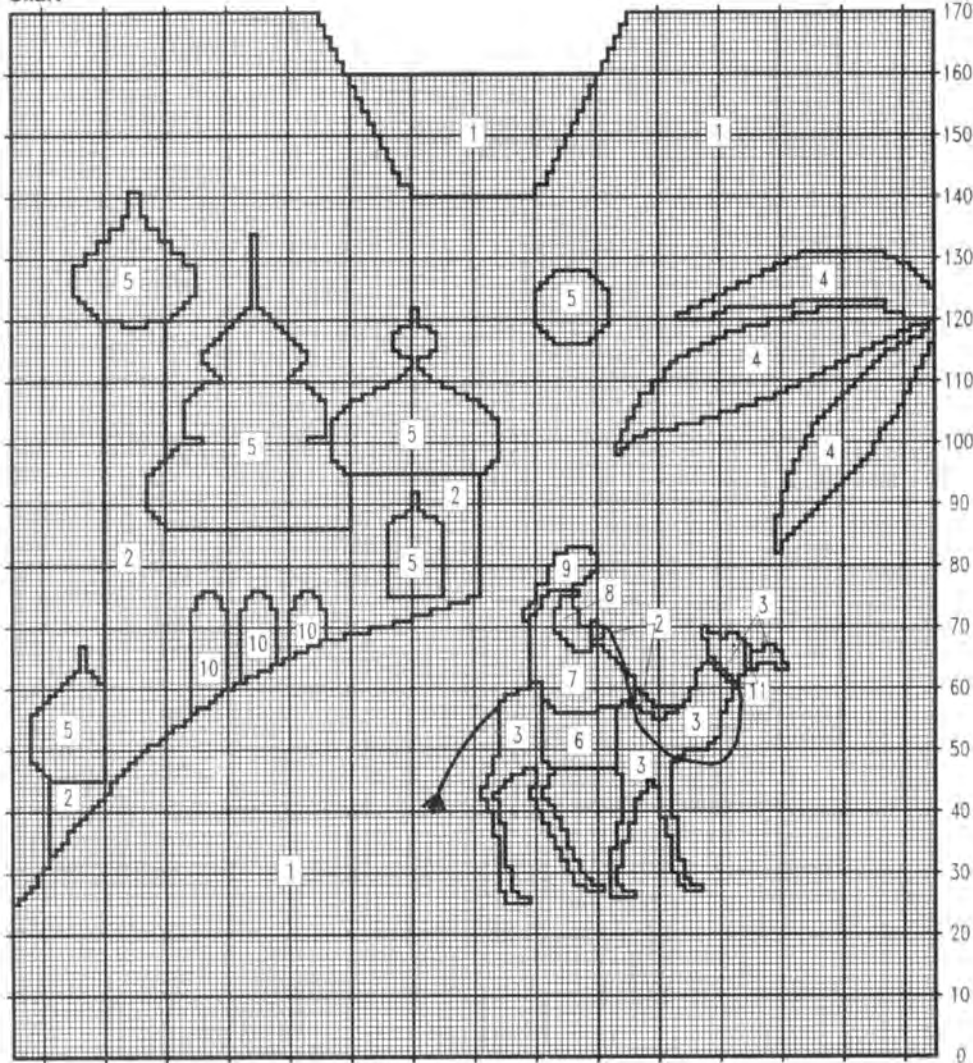

Ribs: 1/1 rib at TD approx. 4-5.
Intarsia: Knitted following the chart. Use separate balls of yarn for each colour. The lead is crocheted in black and the tail in brown. They are sewn on to hang loose. Small areas may also be swiss-darned.
Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.
Front: Cast on with waste yarn 150 sts and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and continue in st st and intarsia. At **RC 78**, mark both edges for armholes. At **RC 140**, shape neck. Set carriage for HP and push to HP the centre 20 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. Shape neck as shown on chart, casting off rem. sts at **RC 170**. 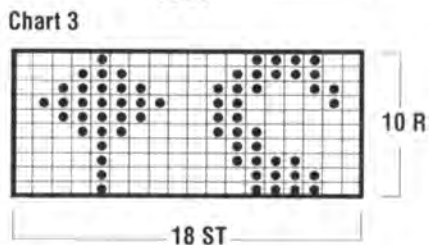
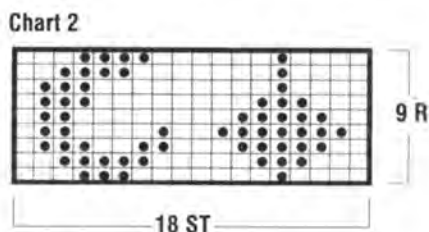
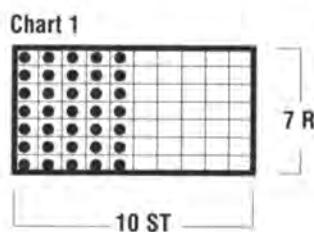

Fairisle pattern: Punch a card or mark mylar sheet or program machine according to the charts. Remember to select needles on last row of stocking stitch. Gold ochre is used as main colour.



Pattern sequence: 14(20) rows gold ochre, 7 rows purple, 7 rows from chart 1, 13(15) rows gold ochre, 9 rows from chart 2, 8 rows dk red, 15(17) rows gold ochre, 7 rows from chart 1, 9 rows grey/green, 7 rows from chart 1, 15(17) rows gold ochre, 8 rows purple, 10 rows from chart 3, 14(16) rows gold ochre, 7 rows from chart 1, 8 rows petrol, 13(15) rows gold ochre, 8(10) rows grey/green = 180(198) rows.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on with gold ochre 130(142) sts and knit 30 rows rib. Set RC 000 and knit, following the pattern sequence. At RC 99(108), make both edges for armholes. At RC 180(198), change to rib and knit 20 rows in gold ochre. Cast off.

Front: Knit as for back.

Sleeves: Close shoulder seams except for 22(24)cm in centre. With purl side facing, pick up 134(146) sts from side3 edge between markers. Knit in main colour and st st, decr. 1 st at each side on every 5th row 27(30) times = 80(86) sts. At the same time, when RC shows 84(90), knit a stripe of 8 rows purple. At RC 140(156), reduce sts to 50(54) and knit 30 rows rib. Cast off.

Finishing: Close side and sleeves seams.

SWEATER WITH FOOTBALLING DOGS

Size: 146/152cm

Machines: Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber or garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 930 with garter carriage.

Material: SCHACHENMAYR Jaeger "Silia" (100% cotton, 140m/50g) approx. 250g green, 50g each in red, yellow, purple, brown, blue, white and black, 4 buttons, 2.5mm crochet hook.

Tension: 27 sts and 36 rows = 10cm. TD approx. 10**.

Ribs: 1/1 rib on garter carriage at TD approx. 8.

Intarsia: Knitted following the chart. Take care to cross the yarns, when

changing colours. The black outlines are embroidered in black stem stitch. The goalposts and cross bar in chain-stitch. For the net, stretch white threads in straight lines across the goalmouth. With sewing cotton fasten down at the crossing points. The goal measures 15X26cm.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on 120 sts and knit rib in stripes of 4 rows each in blue, green, yellow, purple and 3 rows red. Increase sts to 130 and set RC 000. Continue in green to RC 65. Mark both edges for armholes. At RC 142, knit 1 row blue. Change to rib and knit 4 rows each in blue, yellow and purple. Cast off 90 sts at right. On rem. 40 sts knit 12 rows rib in green for buttonband. Cast off.

Front: Cast on and knit rib as on back. Set RC 000 and work intarsia as charted. In upper rib make 4 buttonholes on the 3rd row of yellow, distributing them evenly over the first 40 sts at right.

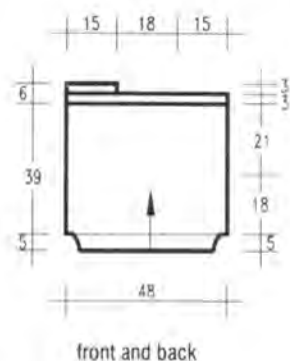

Material: JUNGHANS "Apollo" (50% viscose, 50% polyacryl, 112m/50g) approx. 250g turquoise, 50g each yellow, red, green, black and white. Small amount of brown. 3 Or 3.5mm knitting needles if knitting ribs by hand.

Tension: Intarsia 20 sts and 27 R = 10cm. Moss stitch on machine 21 sts and 37 R = 10cm.

Ribs: with garter carriage: 1/1 rib at TD approx. 9.

Moss stitch with garter carriage: Insert punchcard or program machine and knit at loosest possible TD setting.

Intarsia: Knitted on chunky machine at TD. 0 according to the chart. Smaller areas may be swiss-darned. For details of embroidery see key to chart.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Back: Cast on with waste yarn 84 sts and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit in turquoise st st. to RC 62. Mark both edges for armholes. Knit to RC 104, and shape neck. Push to HP the centre 24 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. Knit each side separately. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once. At RC 112, cast off rem. 23 shoulder sts. Repeat for other side. Return needles from HP to WP and knit 1 row st st. Move sts to standard gauge machine and knit 10 rows in 1/1 rib for neckband with garter carriage. Alternately take sts on knitting needles and knit by hand.

Front: Cast on and knit as for back, but starting the motif from row 1. At RC 62 mark both edges for armholes. 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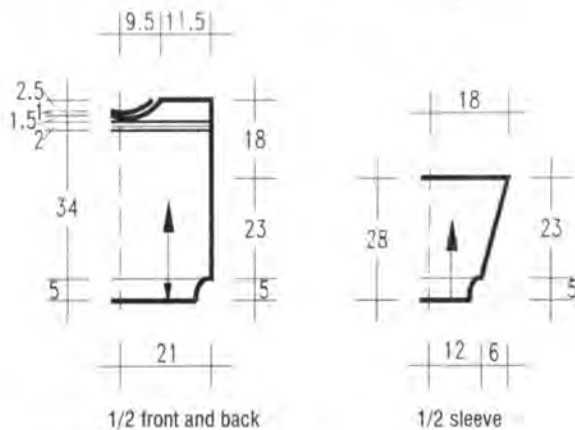
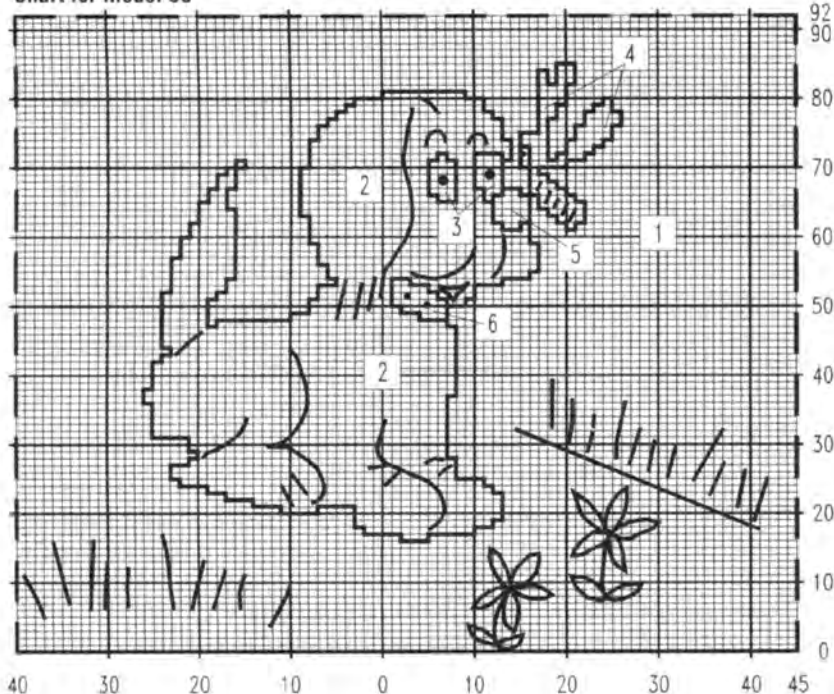

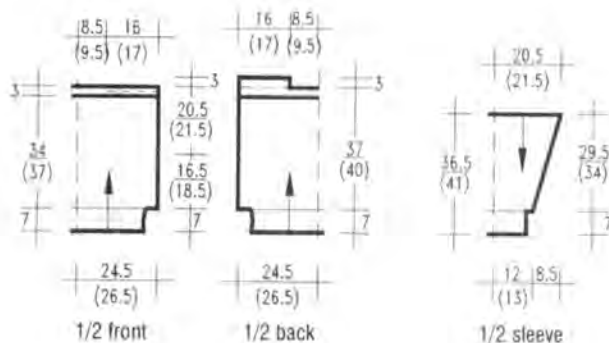

Tension: Front and back: 25 sts and 35 R = 10cm. Sleeves: 26 sts and 34 rows = 10cm. TD approx. 10**.

Ribs: 2/2 rib at TD approx. 7. **Fairisle pattern:** Punch a card repeating the design 3 times across the card or mark mylar sheet. After knitting 8 rows of pattern, knit 4 rows st st, selecting needles for next fairisle pattern on last row.

Colour sequence: With red in feeder 1, change colours in feeder 2 as follows: Rows 1-4 turquoise. Rows 5-8 dk. blue. Repeat this sequence throughout. For sleeves use grey in feeder 1, and colours in feeder 2 in reverse.

Intarsia: Knitted following the chart. It may be necessary to adjust the TD setting when changing from intarsia to st st.

Chart 2 (1/2 sleeve) for model 32



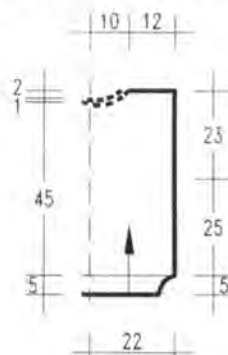
