## **MAN'S FISHERMAN'S RIB SWEATER**

**Materials:** 22 [23, 25] oz. PATONS BEEHIVE Fingering 4 ply, Patonised.

**Measurements:** To fit 38 [40, 42] inch chest.  
Length, 25 [25½, 25¾] ins.  
Sleeve seam, 18½ ins.

**Sizes:** The figures in brackets refer to the medium and large sizes respectively.

**Abbreviations:** K., knit; p., purl; st., stitch; inc., increase; dec., decrease; beg., beginning; alt., alternate; ins., inches; foll., following.

**Tension:** 8 sts. to an inch (No. 3½).

**N.B.:** The number of needles or stitches quoted refers to the total number on both beds combined.

### **BACK.**

Set up 160 [172, 180] needles (80 [86, 90] Back and Front).

**Set at tension** No. 3½.

Cast on and work in k/k rib for 2½ ins.

Proceed in Fisherman's rib with Back and Front Locks at EX until work measures 16½ ins. from beg.

**Shape Armholes** by casting off 6 [8, 8] sts. at beg. of next 2 rows. Dec. 2 sts. (1 back, 1 front) at both ends of 2nd row foll. and every foll. 4th row until 128 [136, 144] needles remain in work.

Continue on these sts. until work measures 8½ [8¾, 9] ins. from beg. of armhole shaping.

**Shape shoulders** by casting off 14 [\*16, 16] sts. at beg. of every row until 44 [44, 48] needles remain in work (\*on 2nd size only cast off 14 sts. instead of 16 sts. at the beg. of last 2 rows). Cast off loosely.

### **FRONT.**

Proceed as on Back until work measures 5½ [5¾, 6] ins. from beg. of armhole shaping.

**Shape Neck** as follows:—

With an odd length of wool, loosely knit 50 [54, 56] sts. at opposite end from Lock moving needles by hand, then push these needles into N.P.

Proceed on remaining sts. as follows:—

**Next row:** Work all across.

**Next row:** Cast off 28 [28, 32] sts.

Now dec. 2 sts. at neck edge on 2nd row foll. and every foll. 4th row until 42 [46, 48] needles remain in work. Continue on these sts. until work measures same as Back to shoulder shaping.

**Shape Shoulder** by casting off 14 [16, 16] sts. at beg. of next and every alt. row until all sts. are cast off.

Rejoin wool to remaining sts. and complete to match first half, reversing all shapings.

### **SLEEVES.**

Set 70 [74, 78] needles (35 [37, 39] Back and Front).

**Set at tension** No. 2½.

Cast on and work in k/k rib for 3 ins.

**Change to tension** No. 3½, and proceed in Fisherman's rib, inc. 2 sts. at beg. of 5th and 6th rows and every foll. 13th and 14th row until 138 [142, 146] needles remain in work. Continue on these sts. until work measures 18½ ins. from beg.

**Shape top** by casting off 6 [8, 8] sts. at beg. of next 2 rows, then dec. 2 sts. at both ends of 2nd row foll. and every foll. 4th row until 106 [106, 110] needles remain in work. Cast off 4 sts. at beg. of next 14 rows.

Cast off.

### **NECKBAND.**

Push up 230 [234, 238] needles.

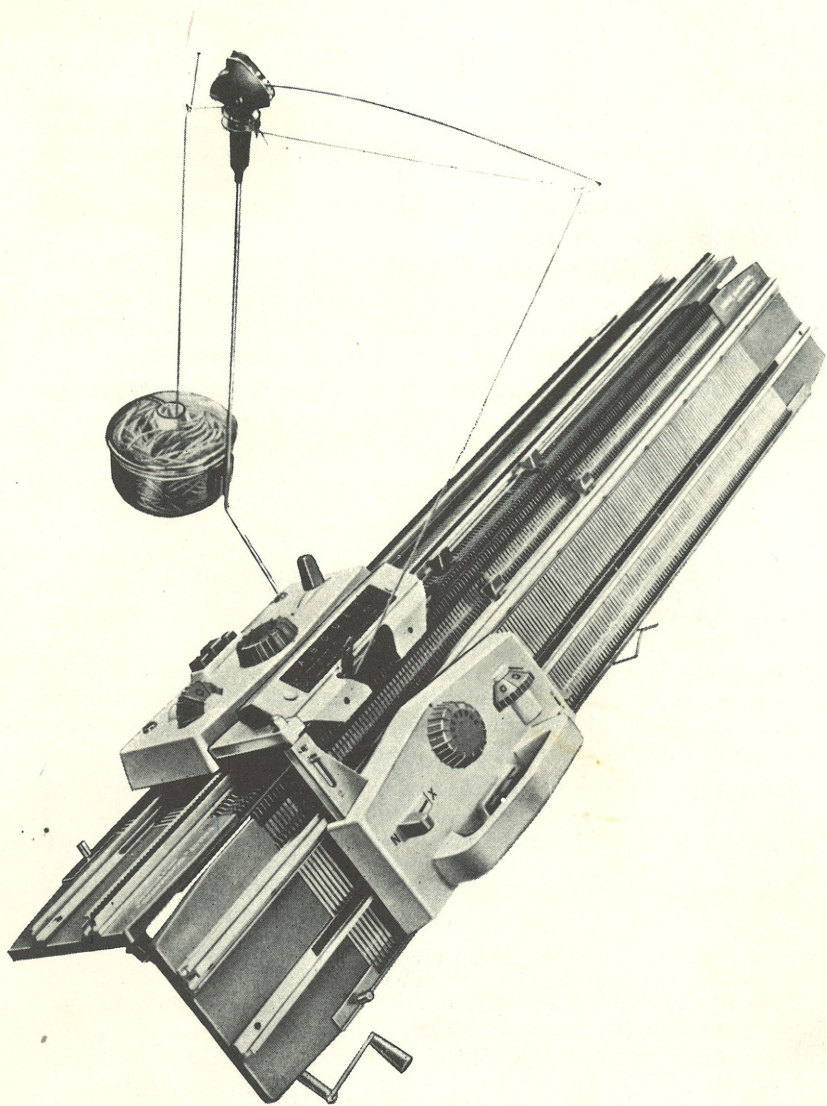
**Set at tension** No. 2½.

Cast on and work in k/k rib for 2½ ins.

Cast off.

### **TO MAKE UP**

Join shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Stitch Sleeves into position. Flat stitch Neckband into position with join at centre Back taking care to maintain elasticity of ribbing. Fold Neckband at centre to inside and flat-stitch to form Double Band.
