Longline sweaters are the favourites this season. They flatter your figure and can be worn with many things.





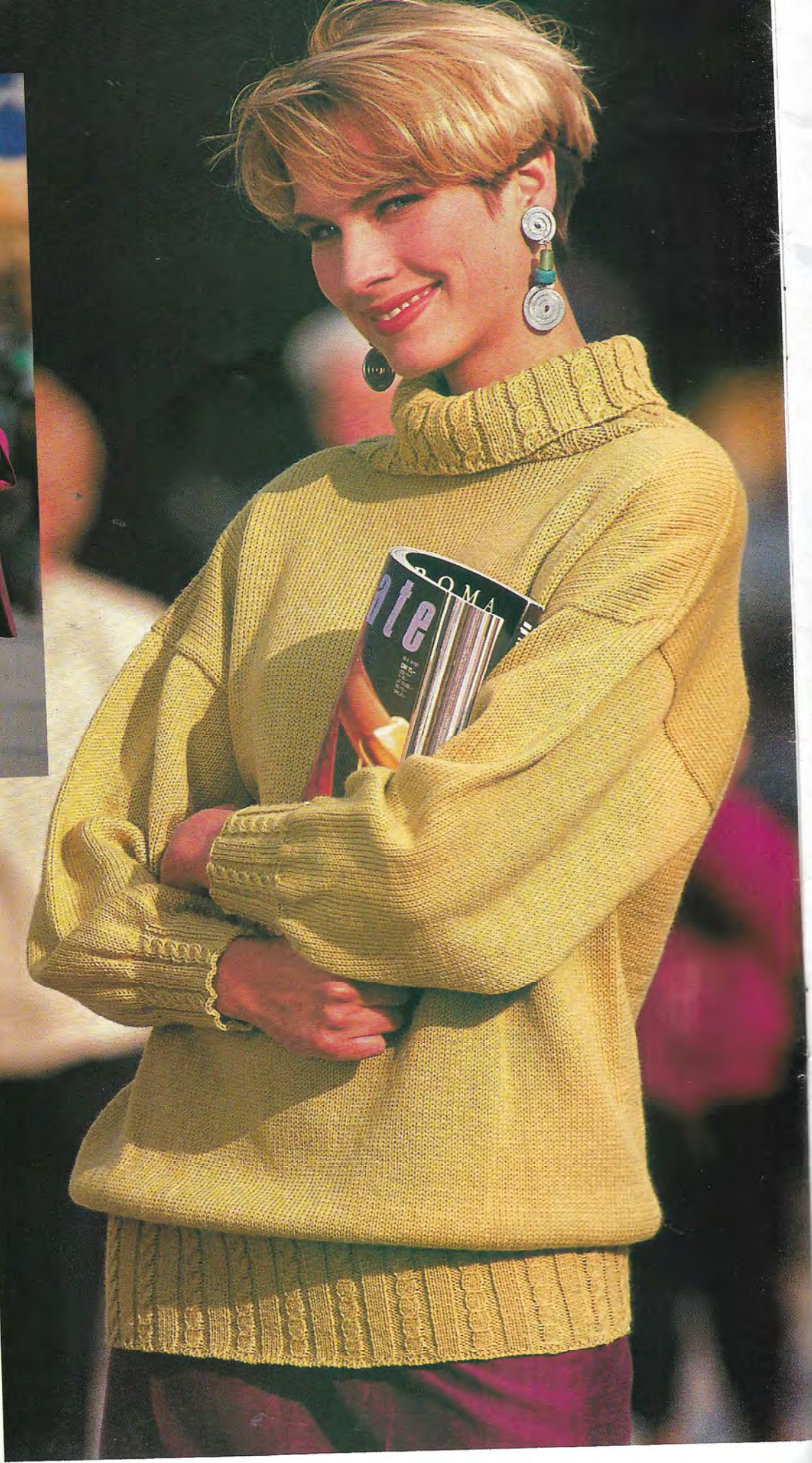


On the left a sweater in pistachio. Cabled welts and the generous collar are very up-to-date.

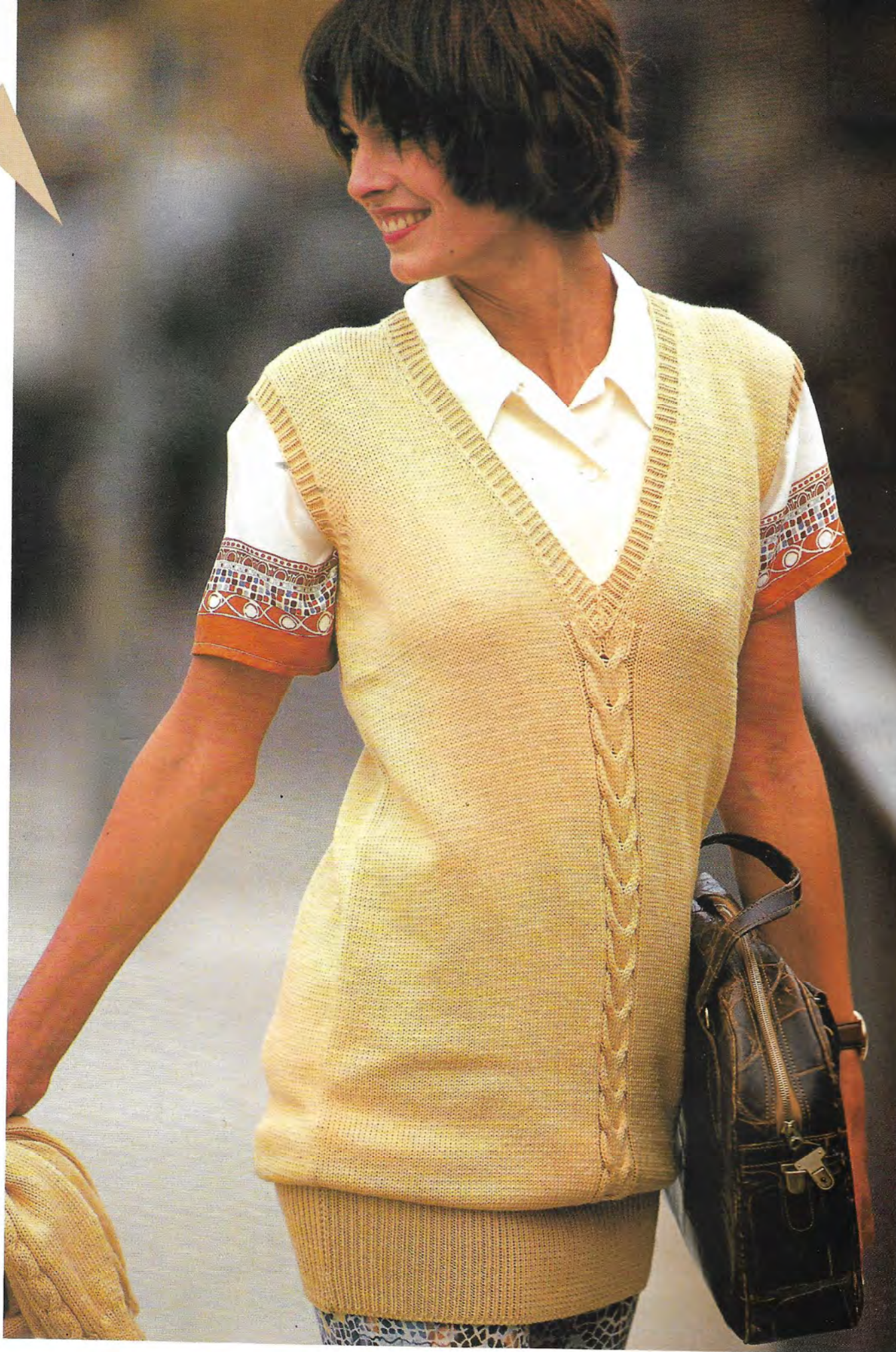

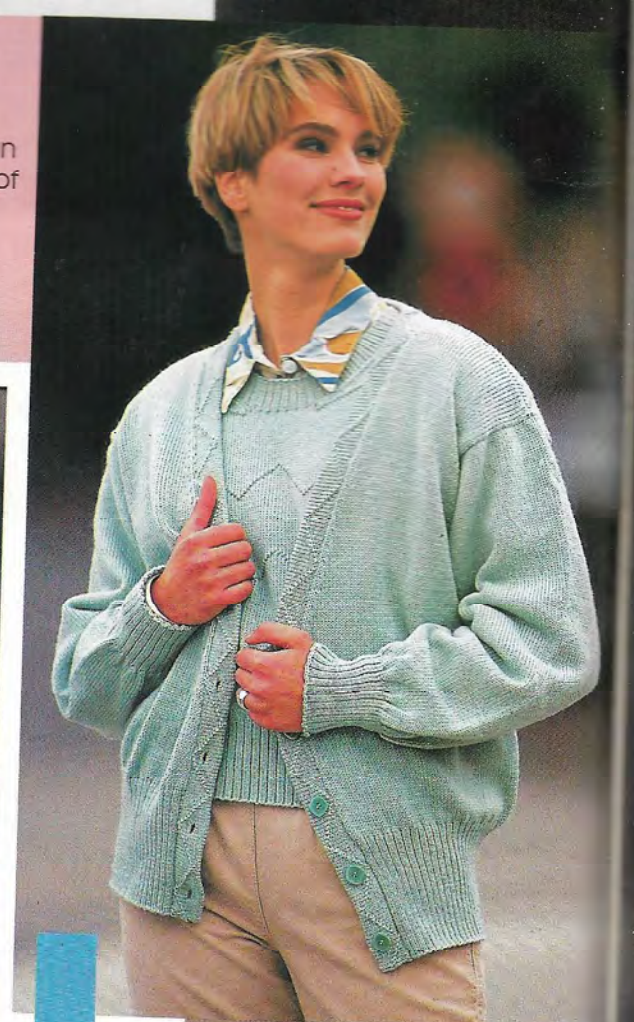

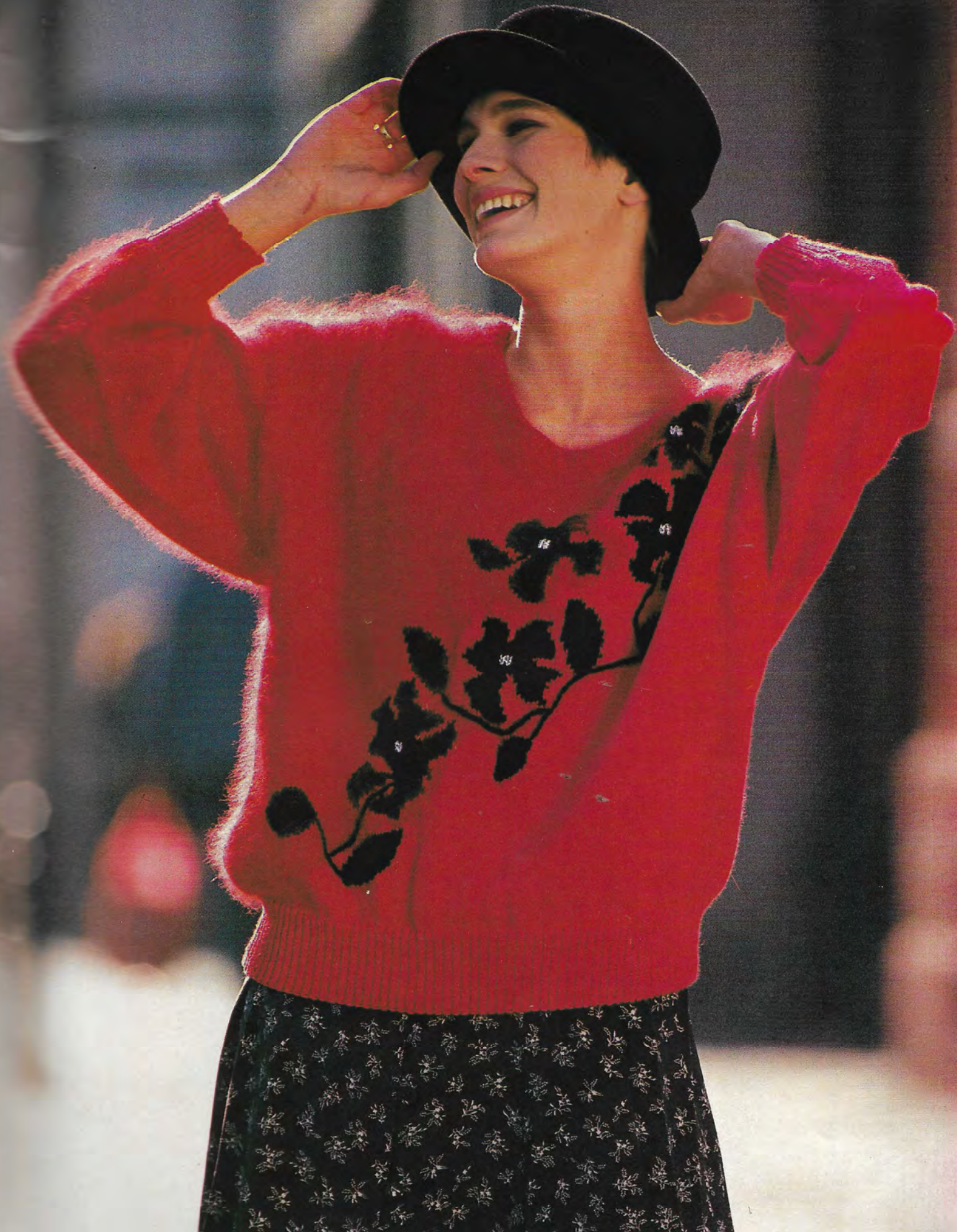

DUSKY PINK

LONGLINE SWEATER

**Size:** 12/14 (16/18) Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge electronic machines with garter carriage or standard gauge machines with ribber. We used a Brother KH 930 with garter car-

riage.

**Material:** SCHOELLER "Zimba Top" (80% wool, 20% polyamid, 150 m/50 g) approx. 700 (750) g dusky pink.

Multi-transfer tool for shapings.

Available as a kit by mailorder from WOLLSTUDIO Jutta Hinrichs, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany, Send Eurocheque for DM 87,00 (DM 91,50) incl. postage.

**Ribs:** 2 x 2 rib on garter carriage at TD 9.

**Main pattern:** The diagram on the following page shows the pattern to row 126. It will only be necessary to program the area within the thick black line for the garter carriage. If using a machine with ribber, sts have to be transferred between beds on every row. The detail of the cable patterns is shown in the separate chart. TD approx. 10°.

**Tension:** 27 sts and 31 rows = 10 cm over main pattern unstretched.

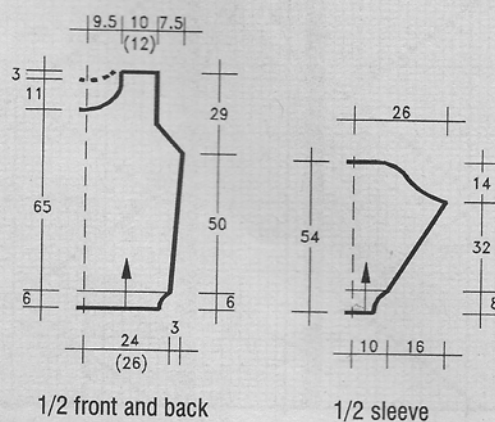
**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 130 (140) sts and knit 24 rows rib. Set RC 000 and continue in main pattern. Increase 1 st at each side on every 17th row 9 times = 148 (158) sts. Knit to RC 156 and shape armholes: Set multitransfer tool with 6 prongs out. At each side move 6 sts in by 3, knit 4 rows. Repeat decreases until 21 sts have been decreased at each side. Knit to RC 238 and shape neck. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 28 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. Knit first side, pushing to HP at neck edge on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once and 3 sts once. Cast off rem. 27 (32) shoulder sts at RC 246. Repeat for other side.

**Neckband:** Return 52 held sts to WP. Knit 12 rows rib and cast off.

**Front:** Cast on and knit as for back to RC 202. Shape neck: Cast off centre 18 sts and knit each side separately. At neck edge cast off on alt. rows 2 sts 8 times and 1 st once. Cast off rem. sts. at RC 246. Repeat for other side.

**Neckband:** Pick up 90 sts from neck edge and hang on needles.



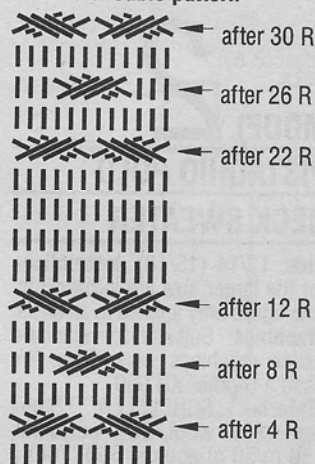
Knit 12 rows rib and cast off.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 54 sts and knit 30 rows rib. Set RC 000 and continue in main pattern. Increase 1 st at each side on every 3rd row 13 times and on every 2nd row 30 times = 140 sts. Knit to RC 100 and shape top: With multi-transfer tool decrease 3 sts at each side on every 4th row 6 times and on alt. rows 9 times = 44 sts. Cast off remaining sts at RC 144.

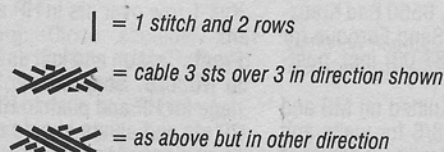
**Finishing:** Close all seams and set in sleeves.

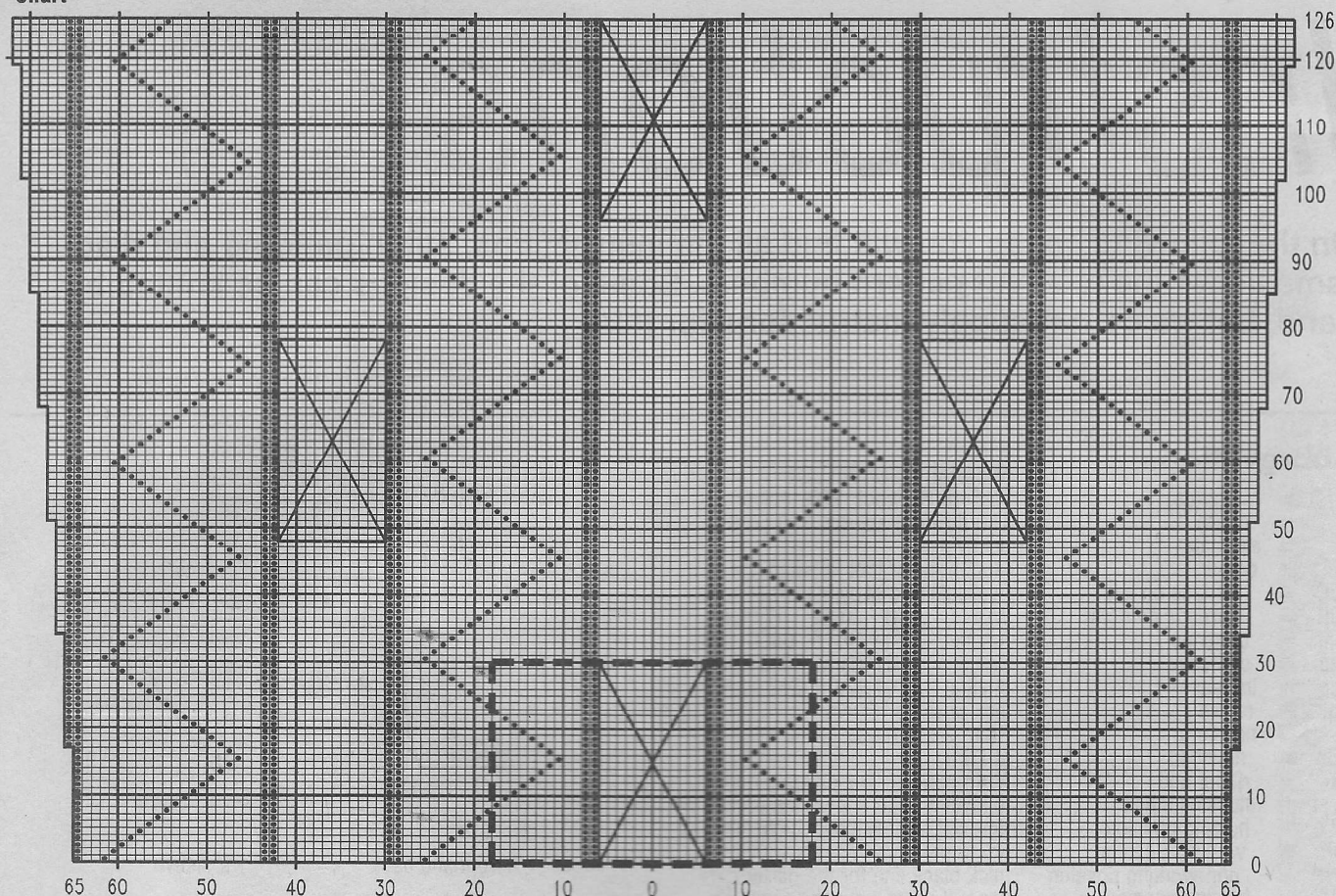
## Details of cable pattern

## MODEL

### PISTACHIO POLO

### NECK SWEATER

**Size:** 12/14 (16/18). Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with ribber. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Material:** SCHOELLER "Zimba Top" (80% wool, 20% polyamid, 150 m/50 g) approx. 650 (700) g green.

Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany, Send Euroque for DM 82,50 (DM 87,00) incl. postage.

**Cable pattern:** Knitted on MB and RB. TD approx. 8/8 for welts and 10/8 for collar. Starting in centre of

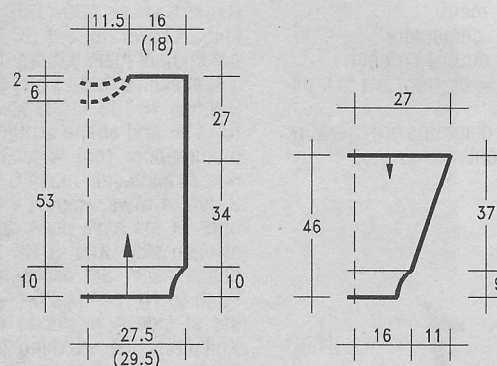
needle bed, place alternately 4 sts on MB and 2 sts on RB. Cable alt. groups of 4 sts on MB on every 6th row.

**Tension:** 26 sts and 33 rows = 10 cm at TD approx. 10 °.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 144 (154) sts. as 1 x 1 rib. Knit zig zag row and 2 circular rows. Transfer sts for cable pattern and knit 42 rows. Transfer all sts to MB. Knit in st st to **RC 112** and mark each side for armholes. Knit to **RC 194** and shape neck. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 36 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. Knit first side, pushing to HP at neck edge on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once and 3 sts once. Knit to **RC 202** and cast off rem. 42 (47) sts. Repeat shaping on other side. Knit 1 row over sts in HP and cast off.

**Front:** Cast on and knit as for back to **RC 176**. Shape neck. Set carriage for HP and push to HP centre 20 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge push to



1/2 front and back

HP on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts 4 times. Cast off rem. shoulder sts at **RC 202**. Repeat shaping on other side. Knit 1 row over sts in HP and cast off.

**Sleeves:** Close shoulder seams. With wrong side facing, pick up 140 sts between markers on side edges and hang on needles. Set RC 000 and knit in st st, decreasing 1 st at each side on every 4th row

1/2 sleeve

28 times = **84 sts**. At **RC 122**, reduce sts to 62. Arrange sts for cable pattern and knit 36 rows. Cast off.

**Collar:** Cast on 144 sts as 1 x 1 rib. Knit zig zag row and 2 circular rows. Transfer sts for cable pattern and knit 60 rows. Cast off loosely.

**Finishing:** Join short edges of collar. Sew collar to neckline, so that cable pattern shows on outside when folded. Close side and sleeve seams.

## MODEL

### GREY HOODED SWEATER

**Size:** 14-18

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with ribber. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Material:** SCHOELLER "Zimba Top" (80% wool, 20% polyamid, 150 m/50 g) approx. 1400 g beige, 3 brown buttons.

Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 150,00 incl. postage.

**Ribs:** 1 x 1 rib at TD approx. 5.

**Half Fishermans Rib:** Knitted on both beds at TD approx. 10/7. The cable panels consist of 13 sts on MB only. For this transfer 13 sts from RB to MB and push empty N to NWP. Cable on every 10th row by crossing sts 1 - 3 with sts 4 - 6. Leave centre stitch and cable sts 8 - 10 with sts 11 - 13 in opposite direction.

**Tension:** 28 sts and 48 rows = 10 cm over pattern.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 193 sts and knit 10 rows rib. Set RC 000 and arrange sts for pattern: Centre 67 sts in Half Fishermans Rib. 13 sts at each side for cable. 23 sts at each side in Half Fishermans Rib. 13 sts

at each side for cable, rem. sts in Half Fishermans Rib = 4 cable panels. Knit straight to RC 160. Cast off 9 sts at beg. of next 2 rows for armholes = 175 sts. Knit to RC 314 and cast off loosely.

**Front:** Cast on and knit as for back to RC 156. Cast off centre 15 sts for front opening and knit each side separately. Cast off 9 sts at beg. of row 160 for armhole. Knit to RC 270 and shape neck. At inner edge cast off on alt. rows 8 sts once, 3 sts 3 times and 1 st 6 times. Cast off rem 57 sts at RC 314. Repeat shaping on other half.

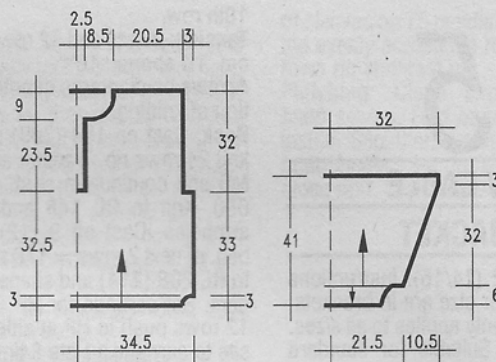
**Sleeves:** Cast on with waste yarn 121 sts in 1 x 1 rib and knit several rows. Change to main yarn and arrange sts for pattern: Centre 45 sts in Half Fishermans Rib. 13 sts at each side for cable panel, remaining sts in Half Fishermans Rib. Set RC 000 and knit in pattern, incr. 1 st at each side on every 5th row 31 times = 183 sts. Cast off all sts at RC 168.

**Cuffs:** Pick up sts from lower edge of sleeves and hang on 60 needles. Knit 1 row. Transfer for 1 x 1 rib. Knit 25 rows and cast off.

**Pockets:** Cast on 61 sts in 1 x 1 rib and knit 10 rows. Set carriages for Half Fishermans Rib. Knit 74 rows and cast off.

**Hood:** Cast on 109 sts in 1 x 1 rib. Set carriages for Half Fishermans Rib. Set RC 000 and knit in pattern to RC 126. At left edge, decrease 1 st on every 3rd row 12 times. Knit to RC 168 and increase 1 st at left edge on next and every foll. 3rd row 12 times. Knit to RC 336 and cast off.

**Front edges:** With wrong side fac-



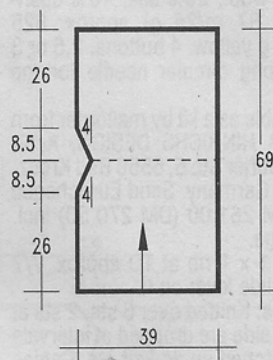

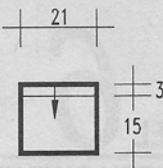
ing, pick up 200 sts from straight edge of hood and hang on needles. TD approx. 10, knit 16 rows st st. Reverse work and knit 1 row for foldline. Reverse work again and knit 16 rows st st. Cast off. From edges of front opening, pick up approx. 70 sts and knit bands as on hood.

**Buttonloops** (knitted 3 times): E-wrap cast on 13 sts, leaving centre N empty for foldline. Knit 60 rows and cast off. With right sides together, fold in half along ladder and stitch. Turn inside out, fold in half and sew to front opening to make buttonloops.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder seams. Fold hood in half and close back seam. Sew to neckline. Join stocking stitch bands. Fold to inside and sew down. Overlap bands at lower edge and slipstitch in position. Position pockets and sew on. Set in Sleeves. Close side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

## MODEL

### YELLOW LONGLINE SLIPOVER

**Size:** 10/12 (14/16) Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with ribber. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Material:** SCHEWE "Cash & Silk" (70% wool, 20% silk, 10% cashmere, 87 m/25 g) approx. 475 (500) g yellow.

Multi-transfer tool for decreases. Available as a kit by mailorder from WOLLSTUDIO Jutta Hinrichs, Adalbert-Stifter Str 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 204,00 (DM 213,50) incl. postage.

**Ribs:** 1 x 1 rib at TD 7/7 with slide lever on II.

**Cable pattern:** Knitted over 12 sts. 2 stitches at each side are dropped at intervals and latched up to form purl stitches. The cable starts 4 rows above the welt and finishes at start of neck shaping.

**Tension:** 28 sts and 32 rows = 10 cm at TD 10°.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 134 (146) sts and knit 46 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB and continue in st st. Set RC 000. Knit to RC 192 and shape armholes. With multi-transfer tool, move 5 outer sts at each side in by 3. Knit 2 rows and repeat decreases until 21 (24) sts have been decreased at each side. Knit straight to RC 248 and shape neck. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 16 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once. Cast off rem. 27 (30) sts at RC 256. Repeat shaping on other side.

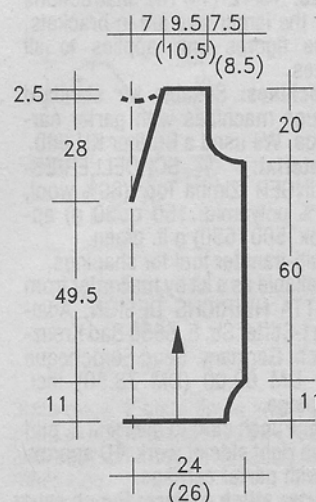
**Neckband:** Return the 38 held sts to WP. Arrange for rib and knit 10 rows. Cast off.

**Front:** Cast on and knit welt as for back. Set RC 000. Knit 4 rows st st. Make cable over 12 centre sts, cabling 6 sts at left to the left and 6 sts at right to the right. Repeat cables on every 10th row. Drop 2 sts either side of cable panel at intervals and latch up to form purl sts.

At RC 158, divide work in centre for V-neck and knit each side separately. Decrease 1 st fully-fashioned at neck edge on every 5th row 19 times. At THE SAME TIME, at RC 192, shape armholes as on back. Cast off rem. shoulder sts at RC 256. Repeat shaping on other side.

**Neckband:** With purl side facing, pick up 78 sts along V-neck from shoulder to lower point of V. Knit 10 rows rib, decreasing 1 st at V on every row. Knit other side to match.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder and neckband seams. Join shaped edges of neckband. Crochet or embroider chain stitch over join. With purl side facing, pick up 101 (109) sts from armholes edge and

hang on needles. Knit 10 rows rib and cast off. Close rem. seams.



# MODEL 5

## YELLOW CABLE

### PANEL JACKET

**Size:** 10/12 (14/16). Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with ribber. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Material:** SCHEWE "Cash & Silk" (80% wool, 20% silk, 10% cashmere, 87 m/25 g) approx. 625 (650) g yellow. 4 buttons. 2.5 or 3 mm long circular needle for the band.

Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 261,00 (DM 270,50) incl. postage.

**Ribs:** 1 x 1 rib at TD approx. 7/7 with slide lever on II.

**Cables:** Knitted over 6 sts. 2 sts at either side are dropped at intervals and latched up as knit sts. Cables are twisted on row 5 and every foll.

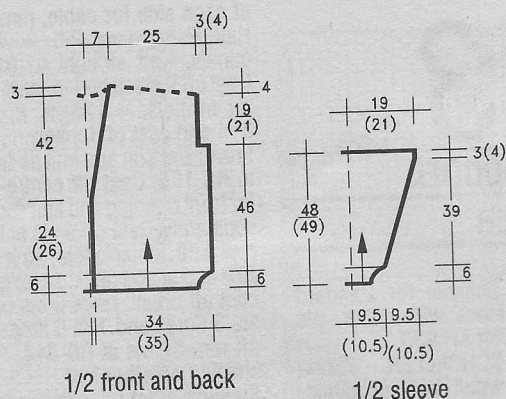
10th row.

**Tension:** 28 sts and 32 rows = 10 cm. TD approx. 10°.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 194 (200) sts and knit 24 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB and continue in st st. Set RC 000. Knit to **RC 148** and shape armholes. Cast off 9 (12) sts at beg. of next 2 rows = 176 sts. Knit to **RC 208 (214)** and shape shoulders. Set carriage for HP. On next 12 rows push to carriage 11 sts 3 times and 12 sts 3 times. AT THE SAME TIME, when RC shows **212 (218)** shape neck with HP. Push to HP centre 16 sts and knit each side separately. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once. Repeat for other side. Knit 1 row over sts in HP for shoulder and cast off. Return 38 sts in HP for neck to WP. Arrange for 1 x 1 rib. Knit 10 rows and cast off.

**Left front:** Cast on 94 (97) sts and knit 24 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB. Set RC 000 and continue in st st. Place cable panel as described 27 sts in from right edge. Knit to **RC 76 (82)** and shape front edge. At right edge decrease 1 st fully-fashioned on next and every foll.



8th row 15 times. AT THE SAME TIME, at **RC 148** shape armhole at left edge as for back. At **RC 208 (214)** shape shoulder as on back.

**Right front:** Cast on and knit as for left front, reversing all shapings.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 56 (62) sts and knit 24 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB. Set RC 000 and continue in st st. Place cable panel over centre 6 sts, dropping 2 sts at each side at intervals and latching them up to form knit sts. AT THE SAME TIME, increase 1 st at each side on every 5th row 25 times (on every 4th row 30 times) = 106 (122) sts. Knit to

**RC 134 (138)** and cast off loosely.

**Front bands:** With circular needle, pick up approx. 220 (228) sts from one front edge and knit 10 rows rib. Cast off. On right front band, make 5 buttonholes in lower 30 (32) cm at even distances.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder and band seams. Set in sleeves. Close side and sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

# MODEL 6

## LT GREEN SWEATER

### WITH ZIGZAGS

**Size:** 10/12 (14/16). Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 860.

**Material:** SCHOELLER/ES-SLINGER "Zimba Top" (80% wool, 20% polyamid, 150 m/50 g) approx. 500 (550) g lt. green.

Multi-transfer tool for shapings. Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 69,00 (DM 73,50) incl. postage.

**Rib:** Punch card to give knit 2, purl 1 on right side of work. TD approx. 5 with garter carriage.

**Garter stitch pattern:** Punch card as given. Pattern consists of 20 rows st st and 13 rows pattern. TD approx. 9 with garter carriage.

**Tension:** 27-28 sts and 36 rows = 10 cm.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Front:** Cast on 144 (156) sts and knit 40 rows rib. Set RC 000 and

continue in pattern of 20 rows st st and 13 rows garter stitch. At **RC 88 (94)** shape armholes. Set multi-transfer tool with 6 prongs out. \* At each side, move 6 sts in by 3. Knit 6 rows. Repeat from \* till 15 (18) sts have been decreased at each side. Knit straight to **RC 114 (128)** and shape neck. Knit several rows waste yarn over centre 20 sts and release from machine. Knit each side separately. At inner edge, decrease 1 st fully-fashioned on alt. rows 15 times = 32 (35) sts. Knit to **RC 170 (182)** and cast off. Repeat for other side.

**Neckband:** Hang 20 sts from waste yarn on needles. Pick up 51 sts at each side from shaped edge = 122 sts. Knit 14 rows rib and cast off.

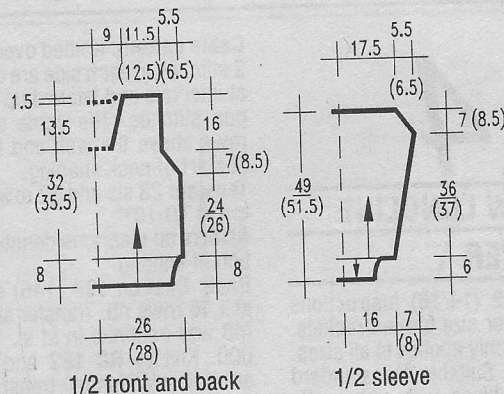
**Back:** Cast on and knit as for front to **RC 88 (94)**. Shape armholes as on front. Knit straight till RC shows **162 (176)** and shape back neck. Take centre 24 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage to NWP with nylon cord. At neck edge take to NWP on alt. rows 7 sts once, 4 sts once and 2 sts once. Cast off rem. shoulder sts as on front. Repeat shaping on other side. Return sts held on nylon cord to WP. Knit 14 rows rib and cast off.

**Sleeves:** Cast on with waste yarn 88 (90) sts and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and change to main yarn. Starting with 2 rows st st, knit in pattern. Increase 1 st at each side on every 6th row 20 (22) times = 128 (134) sts. At **RC 130 (134)** shape top. Decrease 3 sts at

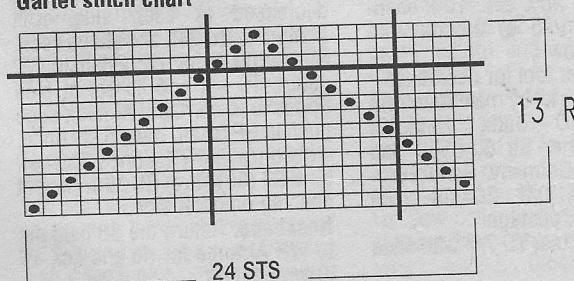
each side on every 6th row as described for front 5 (6) times = 98 sts. Cast off rem. sts at **RC 156 (166)**.

**Cuffs:** Pick up sts from lower edge of sleeves and hang on 69 needles, decreasing evenly across the row. Knit 30 rows rib and cast off.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder and neckband seams. Set in sleeves, gathering top slightly. Close side and sleeve seams.

## MODEL

### LT. GREEN JACKET

**Size:** 10/12 (14/16) Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 860.

**Material:** SCHOELLER/ES-SLINGER "Zimba Top" (80% wool, 20% polyamid, 150 m/50 g) approx. 600 (650) g lt. green. 5 buttons. Multi-transfer tool.

Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 78,00 (DM 82,50) incl. postage.

**Ribs:** Punch card to give knit 2, purl 1 rib on right side of work. TD approx. 5 with garter carriage.

**Garter stitch pattern:** See pattern for model 6.

**Tension:** 27-28 sts and 36 rows = 10 cm at TD approx. 9.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 156 (168) sts and knit 55 rows rib. Set RC 000 and continue in st st. At RC 90 (96) shape armholes. Set multi-transfer tool with 6 prongs out. \* At each side, move 6 sts in by 3. Knit 6 rows. Repeat from \* till 18 (21) sts have been decreased at each side.

Knit straight to RC 180 (190) and shape neckline. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 20 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once. Cast off rem. 38 (41) shoulder sts at RC 192 (202). Repeat shaping on other side. Return the 44 sts held for neck to WP. Pick up 4-5 sts from straight edge at each side. With garter carriage knit 1 row st st. Knit 13 rows pattern. Knit 14 rows st st. Cast off.

**Right front:** Cast on 78 (84) sts and knit 55 rows rib. Set RC 000 and continue in st st. At RC 66 (70) start shaping front slope by decreasing at left edge 1 st fully-fashioned on every 5th row 22 times. AT THE SAME TIME, at RC 90 (96) shape armholes as described for back at right edge. Cast off rem. 38 (41) sts at RC 192

(202).

**Buttonhole band:** With purl side facing, pick up front edge and hang on 182 (192) needles. If possible, hang sts so that pattern matches backneck band at shoulder. Knit 1 row. Knit 13 rows garter stitch pattern. Knit 14 rows st st. AT THE SAME TIME, on rows 7 and 21, make 5 buttonholes in lower part of band at even distances. Cast off.

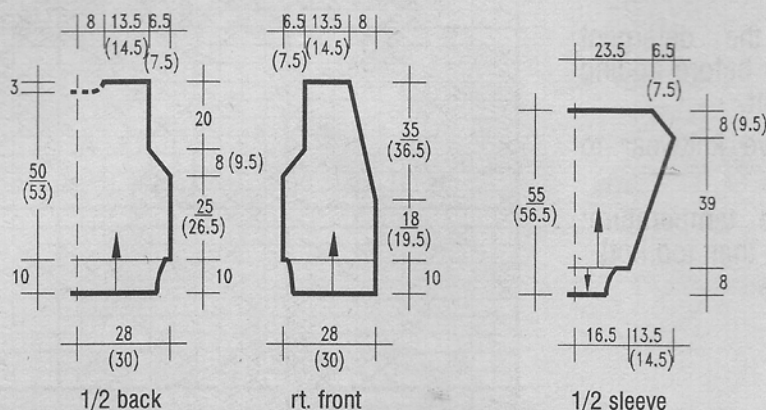
**Left front:** Knit as for right front, reversing all shapings. Omit buttonholes on band.

**Sleeves:** With waste yarn cast on 92 sts and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and continue in lt. green and st st. Increase 1 st at each side on every 4th row 27 (18) times and on every 3rd row 10 (22) times = 166 (172) sts. At RC 140 shape top. Decrease 18 (21) sts at each side as described for back. Cast off rem. 130 sts at RC 172 (178).

**Cuffs:** Pick up sts from lower edge

of sleeves on 75 needles, decreasing evenly across the row. Knit 36 rows rib and cast off.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder and band seams. Fold band in half to inside. Slipstitch down and finish buttonholes. Set in sleeves and close rem. seam. Sew on buttons.

**Size:** 8/10 (12/14). Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge electronic machines with ribber or garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Material:** JUNGHANS "Baumwoll-Color" (51% cotton, 25% viscose, 24% polyacryl, 250 m/100 g) approx. 550 (600) g red. "Gold & Silver" (65% polyamid, 35% met. polyester, 260 m/100 g) approx. 25 g silver, "Angora Royal" (70% angora, 30% wool, 472 m/100 g) approx. 25 g each black and white. Multi-transfer tool for the shapings.

**Ribs:** 2 x 2 rib at TD approx. 8 with garter carriage.

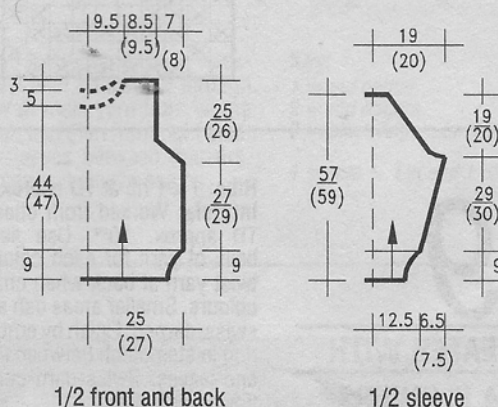
**Fairisle pattern:** Stitch World Pat-

tern 71 or program machine from chart on next page. TD approx. 10°. Use red in feeder I. Change colour in feeder II as follows: rows 1 - 5 silver. Omit rows 6 - 14. Rows 14 - 50 white. Omit rows 51 - 59. Rows 60 - 64 silver.

**Tension:** 30 sts and 35 rows = 10 cm at TD approx. 10°.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 130 (142) sts and knit 36 rows rib. Remove work from machine. Re-hang on 150 (162) needles, incr. evenly across the row. Set RC 000 and continue in st st. Knit to RC 96 (102) and shape armholes. Set multi-transfer tool with 6 prongs out. At each side decrease 3 sts by moving 6 sts in by 3. Knit 6 rows. Repeat the decreases until 21 (24) sts have been decreased at each side. Knit straight to RC 172 (182) and shape neck. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 28 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. On first side push to HP at neck edge on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once and 2 sts once. Cast off rem. 26 (29) sts at RC 182 (192). Repeat shaping on other side.



**Neckband:** Return sts from HP to WP. Pick up 1 or 2 extra sts at each side. Knit 12 rows rib and cast off.

**Front:** Cast on and knit rib as for back. Increase to 150 (162) sts. Set RC 000 and continue in red st st to RC 96 (102). Shape armholes as on back. AT THE SAME TIME, knit 2 rows black, 46 rows fairisle pattern, 2 rows black. Continue in red st st to RC 154 (164) and shape neck. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 24 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows

3 sts once, 2 sts 4 times and 1 st once. Knit straight to RC 182 (192) and cast off. Repeat shaping on other side.

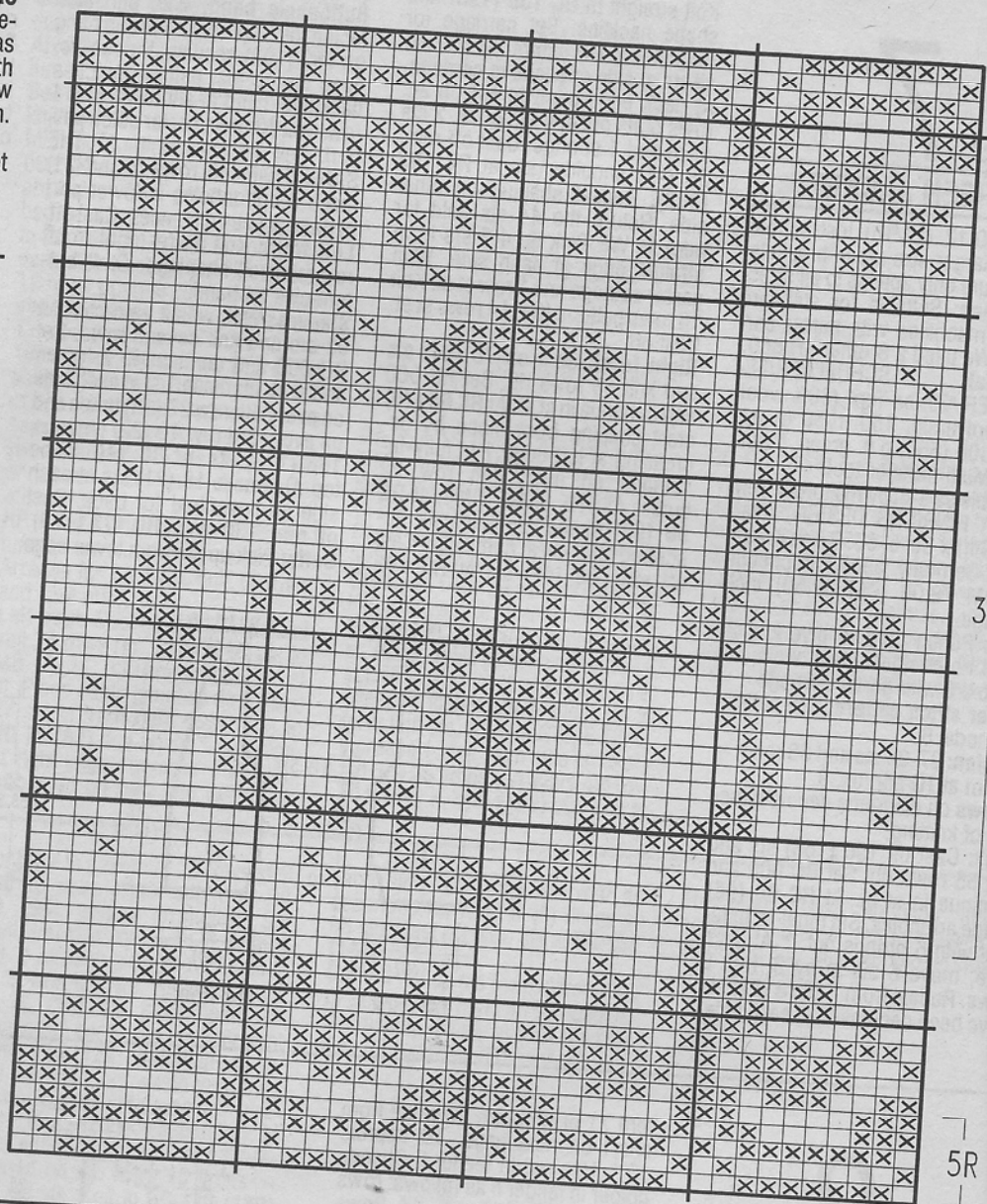
**Neckband:** Return sts from HP to WP. Pick up 10 - 12 extra sts from straight edge on either side. Knit 12 rows rib and cast off.

**Sleeves:** Cast on in red 58 sts and knit 36 rows rib. Increase stitches to 76. Set RC 000 continue in st st. Increase 1 st at each side on every 5th row 20 times (on every 5th row cont. next page



10 times and on every 4th row 13 times) = 116 (122) sts. Knit to **RC 102 (106)** and shape top. Decrease 3 stitch at each side as described for back on every 6th row 7 times and on every 4th row 7 (8) times = 32 sts. Cast off rem. sts at **RC 168 (176)**.  
**Finishing:** Close all seams and set in sleeves.

## Caring for your knitted garments:

Wash carefully by hand. Don't rub, but squeeze gently in the solution. The dirt will be removed, as the water can get to the fibres.

Dissolve the detergent thoroughly before adding the garment.

Never leave knitwear to soak.

Watch the temperature: better cool than too hot!

## MODEL 9 RED SWEATER WITH INTARSIA FLOWERS

**Size:** 12 - 16

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with ribber and intarsia carriage. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Material:** JUNGHANS "Baumwoll-Color" (51% cotton, 25% viscose, 24% polyacryl, 250 m/100 g) approx. 300 g red, "Angora Royal" (70% angora, 30% wool, 485 m/100 g) approx. 125 g red and 25 g black. Small amount of black cotton yarn.

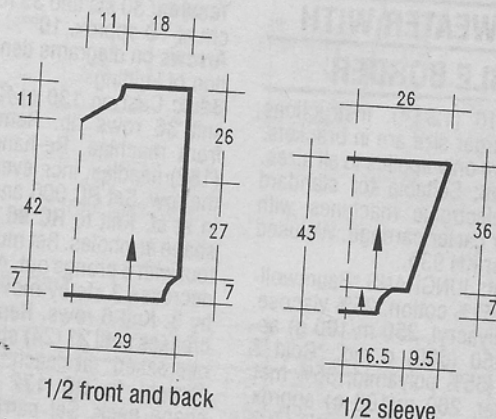
**Ribs:** 1 x 1 rib at TD approx. 6/6.  
**Intarsia:** Worked from chart with TD approx. 10°. Use separate balls of yarn for each colour and twist yarn at back when changing colours. Smaller areas can also be swiss-darned. Finish by embroidering in stemstitch between flowers and leaves. Swiss-darn centre of flowers in silver.

**Tension:** 25 sts and 33 rows = 10 cm over stocking stitch.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Front:** Cast on 130 sts and knit 28 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB, increasing to 146 sts evenly across the row. Set RC 000 and knit intarsia pattern from chart. At **RC 90**, mark both side edges for armholes. At **RC 141**, start neck shaping as shown on chart. Cast off shoulder sts at **RC 176**.

**Back:** Cast on and knit as for front,

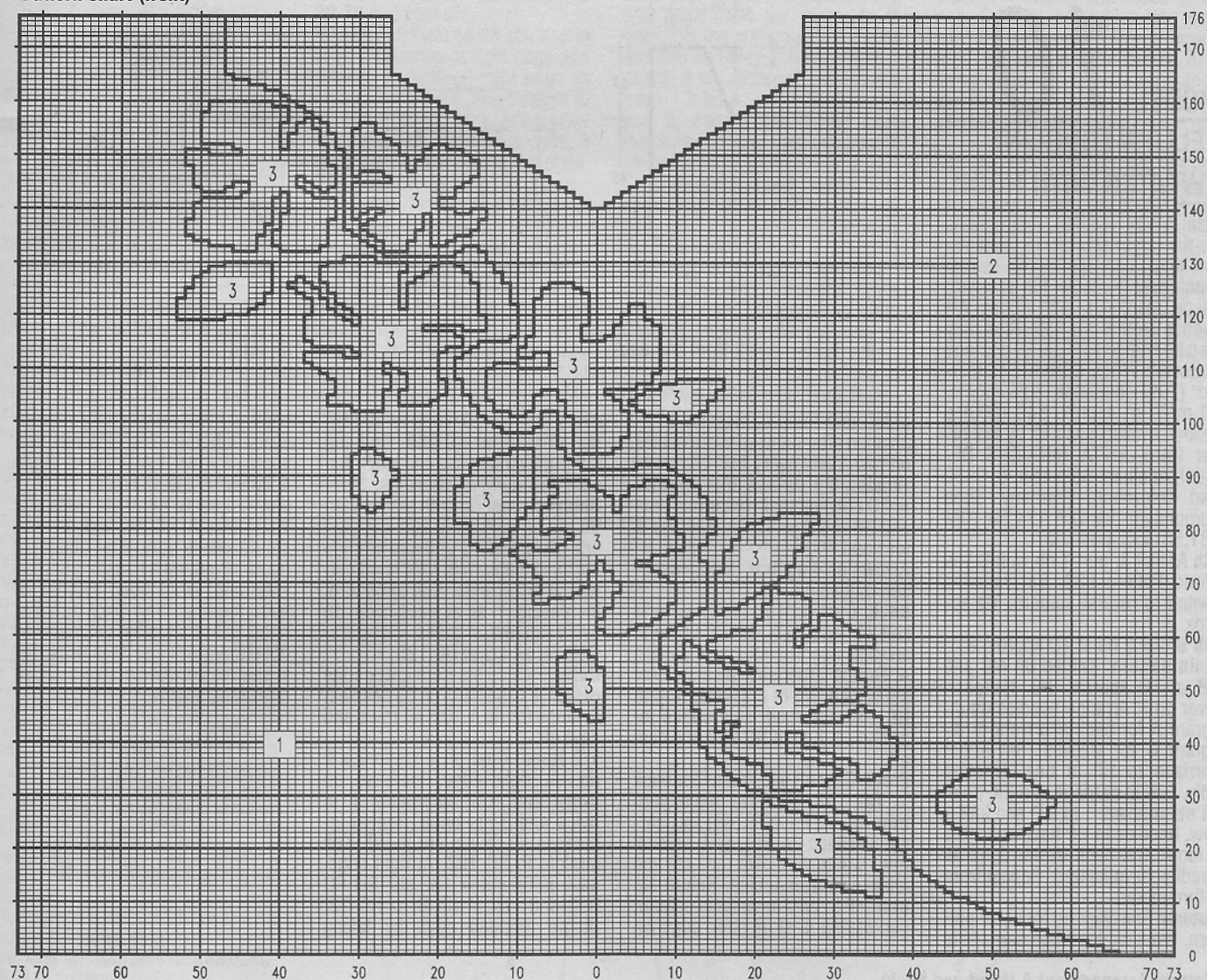
**Left sleeve:** Cast on with waste yarn 84 sts and knit several rows. Change to red cotton. Set RC 000 and knit in st st, increasing 1 st at each side on every 5th row 23

**Cuff:** Cast on 56 sts in red cotton and knit 28 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB. Pick up sts from lower edge of sleeve and hang on needles, decreasing evenly across the

row. Knit 1 row and cast off.  
**Right sleeve:** Knit as for left sleeve, using red Angora.  
**Cuff:** Knit as for left cuff.  
**Neckband:** With red Angora, cast on 90 sts and knit 8 rows 1 x 1 rib. Push empty needles on both beds

to WP and knit 2 circular rows. Knit several rows waste yarn and release from machine. Knit a second band to match.  
 Finishing: Embroider the front. Close shoulder seams. Join neckband pieces. With seams at centre

front and back, pin band to neckline. Sew with backstitch through last row of main yarn from wrong side first, and then from right side. Set in sleeves between markers. Close side and sleeve seams.

**Key:**

- 1 = red cotton
  - 2 = red Angora
  - 3 = black Angora or cotton
- 1 square = 1 st and 1 row.

**Don't forget to check your tension!**

Before starting to knit, check the number of stitches and rows to 10cm against those given in the pattern. Cast on at least 70 sts and knit 10 rows at various tension settings to find the one most suitable for your yarn. At this setting, knit 10 rows. Knit 1 row contrast yarn. Knit 30 rows in pattern and mark stitch 21 at left and right of centre with contrast yarn. Knit a further 30 rows. Knit 1 row contrast. Knit 10 rows pattern. Remove knitting from machine and pull lengthwise. Let knitting rest for several hours. With the Knitmaster "Green for standard gauge or "Blue" ruler for chunky machines, determine the number of stitches and rows between the marks of contrast yarn. If they do not agree with the tensions given, adjust the settings, knit a different size or work out the number of stitches needed for the garment.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with ribber. We used a Brother KH 930. Ribs may also be knitted with garter carriage

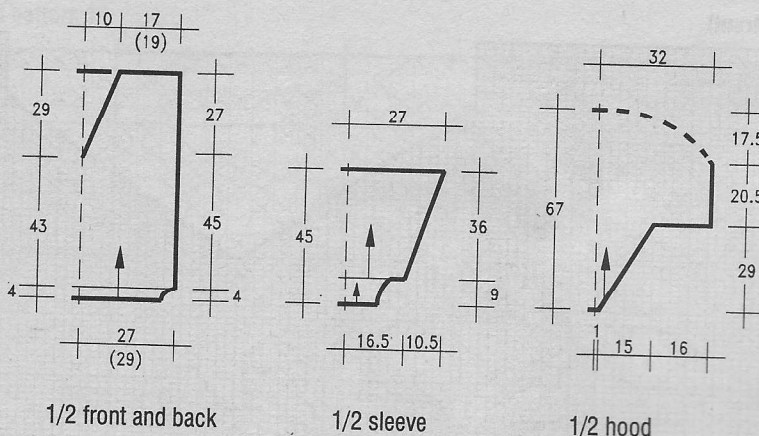
**Material:** WOLL SERVICE "Super-kid" (70% kid mohair, 30% acrylic, 90 m/20 g) approx. 540 (600) g yellow. Available as a kit by mail-order from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 174,50 (DM 181,50) incl. postage.

**Rib A:** knit 2, purl 1 rib with Stitch World Pattern 533. Set variation switch to reverse pattern. TD approx. 3.

**Rib B:** 2 x 2 rib at TD approx. 8.

**Main pattern:** Knitted on MB and RB at TD approx. 8/8. Halfpitch lever on P. Arrange needles as diagram A for back and front or diagram B for sleeves. Set ribber carriage to HP in one direction only. \* With carriage at right, push all sts marked \* to HP and knit 1 row. Needles in HP have collected a loop. Knit back to the right, all needles have knitted. Repeat from \* throughout.

**Cables:** See diagram for cable pattern. Work cables when carriage is



at left and bring all needles to E-position after cabling. Work cables on row 4 and every foll. 10th row. **Tension:** 29 sts and 35 - 36 rows = 10 cm over main pattern. 41 sts and 36 rows = 10 cm over rib B for hood.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 156 (168) sts and knit 21 rows rib A. Set RC 000 and arrange needles for main pattern A. For the larger size the additional sts are shown in brackets. Knit to **RC 160** and mark side edges for armholes. Knit to **RC 258** and cast off.

**Front:** Cast on and knit as for back to **RC 153**. Remove main yarn from feeder. Push 78 (84) sts nearest carriage to HP. Knit several rows waste yarn over rem. sts and release from machine. Return sts from HP to WP. Continue in pattern, decreasing 1 st at neck edge on

every 3rd row 29 times = 49 (55) sts. Cast off at **RC 258**. Re-hang sts from waste yarn and knit other side, reversing all shapings.

**Sleeves:** Cast on with waste yarn 96 sts on both beds and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and arrange sts as in diagram B, extending pattern at either side. Knit in pattern, increasing 1 st at each side on every 4th row 31 times = 158 sts. Cast off all sts at **RC 128**.

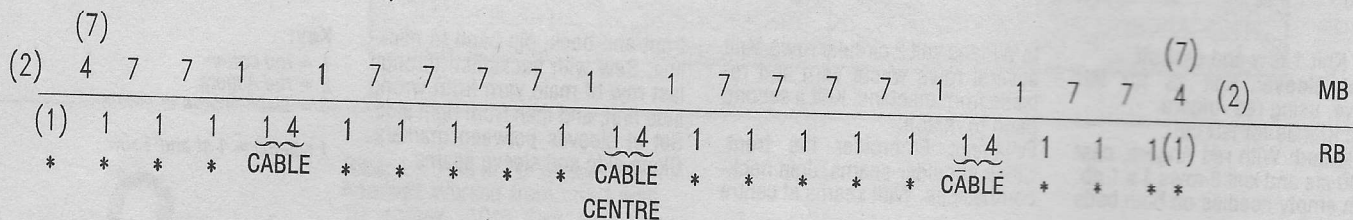
**Cuffs:** Pick up sts from lower edge of sleeves and hang on 66 needles. Arrange for rib A. Knit 41 rows and cast off.

**1/2 Hood:** Cast on 4 sts in 2 x 2 rib. At right edge, increase on every 2nd row alternately 1 st twice and 2 sts once. Repeat increases till 66 sts are in WP. Knit straight to **RC 102**. At right edge, cast on 66 sts = 132 sts. Set RC 000 and knit in rib B to **RC 72**. Shape rounded edge by taking

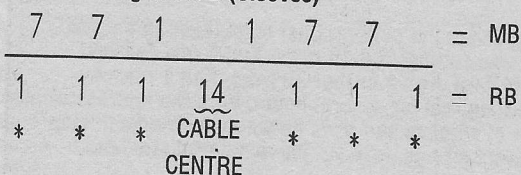
back on nylon cord at right edge on every 4th row 1 st 4 times. On alternate rows 1 st 7 times, 2 sts 4 times, 3 sts 5 times, 4 sts 3 times, 5 sts twice, 6 sts twice and 7 sts once. At **RC 136** take off rem. sts on waste yarn. Knit other 1/2 hood, reversing all shapings.

**Finishing:** Graft open stitches of hood together. Sew back seam of hood. Close shoulder seams. Sew hood to V-neck and back neck. Set in sleeves between markers. Close remaining seams.

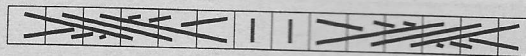
#### Pattern Arrangement A (front and back)




#### Pattern Arrangement B (Sleeves)



## GREY MOHAIR

## JACKET AND MUFF

Size: 12 - 14

**Machines:** Suitable for Bond Classic. Yarn NOT suitable for other chunky machines.

**Material:** AUSTERMANN "Salome" (75% mohair, 25% polyacryl, 75 m/50 g) approx. 850 g grey for the jacket and 150 g for the muff. Small amounts of accent yarn in matching colour. Glass beads. Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 214,00 incl. postage. 5 or 6 mm knitting needles. 4 mm crochet hook.

**Cable strip knitted by hand:** Cast on 10 sts. Row 1: knit. Row 2 and all foll. even rows: purl. Row 3: Edge stitch, 2 sts on cable needle to front of work, knit 2, knit 2 from cable needle, 2 sts on cable needle, edge stitch. Row 5: Edge stitch, 2 sts on cable needle to back of work, knit 2, knit 2 from cable needle, 2 sts on cable needle to front of work, knit 2, knit 2 from cable needle, edge stitch. Row 7: knit. Repeat rows 1 - 8.

**Stocking stitch:** Stitch plate 4 using alternate needles and yarn double.

**Tension:** 11 sts and 13 rows = 10 cm with double yarn.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 48 sts. Set RC 000 and knit in st st, increasing 1 st at each side on every 8th row 4 times = 56 sts. At RC 40, shape armholes. Cast off at each side on alt. rows 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1

st twice = 42 sts. Knit straight to RC 70 and cast off.

**Right front:** Cast on 28 sts. Knit in st st, increasing at right edge and shaping armhole at right edge as on back = 25 sts. Knit straight to RC 62 and shape neck. At left edge cast off on alt. rows 6 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once. Cast off rem. 13 sts at RC 70.

**Left front:** Cast on and knit as for right front, reversing all shapings.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 36 sts. Set RC 000 and knit in st st, increasing 1 st at each side on every 4th row 10 times = 56 sts. At RC 46, shape top.

Cast off at each side on alt. rows 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once. Decrease 1 st at each side on foll. 4th row. Decrease 1 st each side on foll. 8th row. Decrease 1 st at each side on foll. 4th row. Decrease 1 st at each side on foll. alt. rows 3 times and 3 sts once. Cast off rem. 26 sts at RC 76.

**Finishing:** Close all seams. Set in sleeves, gathering top slightly. Knit cable strip over 10 sts to fit lower edge of jacket, using single strand of yarn plus 1 strand accent yarn. Sew strip to lower edge. For wide trim on right front, cast on 20 sts and knit 2 sts of cables, separating

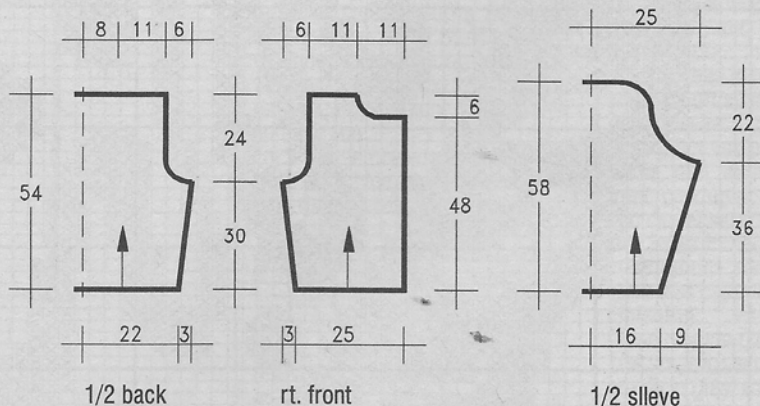
them with 2 purl sts. Stitch to front. Knit neck band the same, to fit neck. For the cuffs, cast on 44 sts and knit as follows: Edge stitch, \* purl 2, 8 sts cable pattern. Repeat from \* 3 times and finishing with purl 2, edge stitch. When work measures 17 cm, cast off. Sew to sleeves.

Crochet dc's along right front edge, making 6 buttonholes on body and 2 on collar. Buttonholes consist of 4 chains, 1 picot (3 chains, 1 dc in 1 st chain) and 4 chains. Crochet the buttons: Make 4 chains and close to a ring. Crochet trebles into the ring to make a ball. Close round with a slipstitch. Crochet a second round of trebles. Stuff with fibre filling. Draw thread through top to close and fasten off.

The leaves and flowers are either knitted or crocheted. Make a short chain and work a row of dc, trebles, double trebles, trebles and dc's on both sides. Crochet 1 row crabstitch around outside of leaf. For flowers crochet 5 chains and close to a ring. Make 12 dc's into the ring and close with a slip stitch. On next row crochet 1 dc and 5 chains alternately to form a rosette. For the flower centre,

crochet 4 chains and close to a ring. Crochet 14 trebles into the ring and fasten off. Sew a large bead or stone into the centre. Arrange flowers at random and crochet a chain between them.

**Muff:** For the centre piece, cast on 25 sts and knit 62 rows st st. Cast off. For side pieces, knit cable strips over 14 sts each, starting and finishing with 2 purl sts. Sew in position. From these side pieces pick up 54 sts from outer edge and knit 10 cm in st st. If required, line the main part of muff. Fold st st band in half and sew down on inside. Insert elastic in hem. Close seam and make applique flowers if wished.

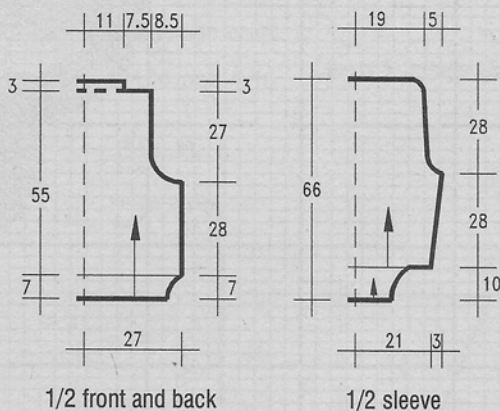

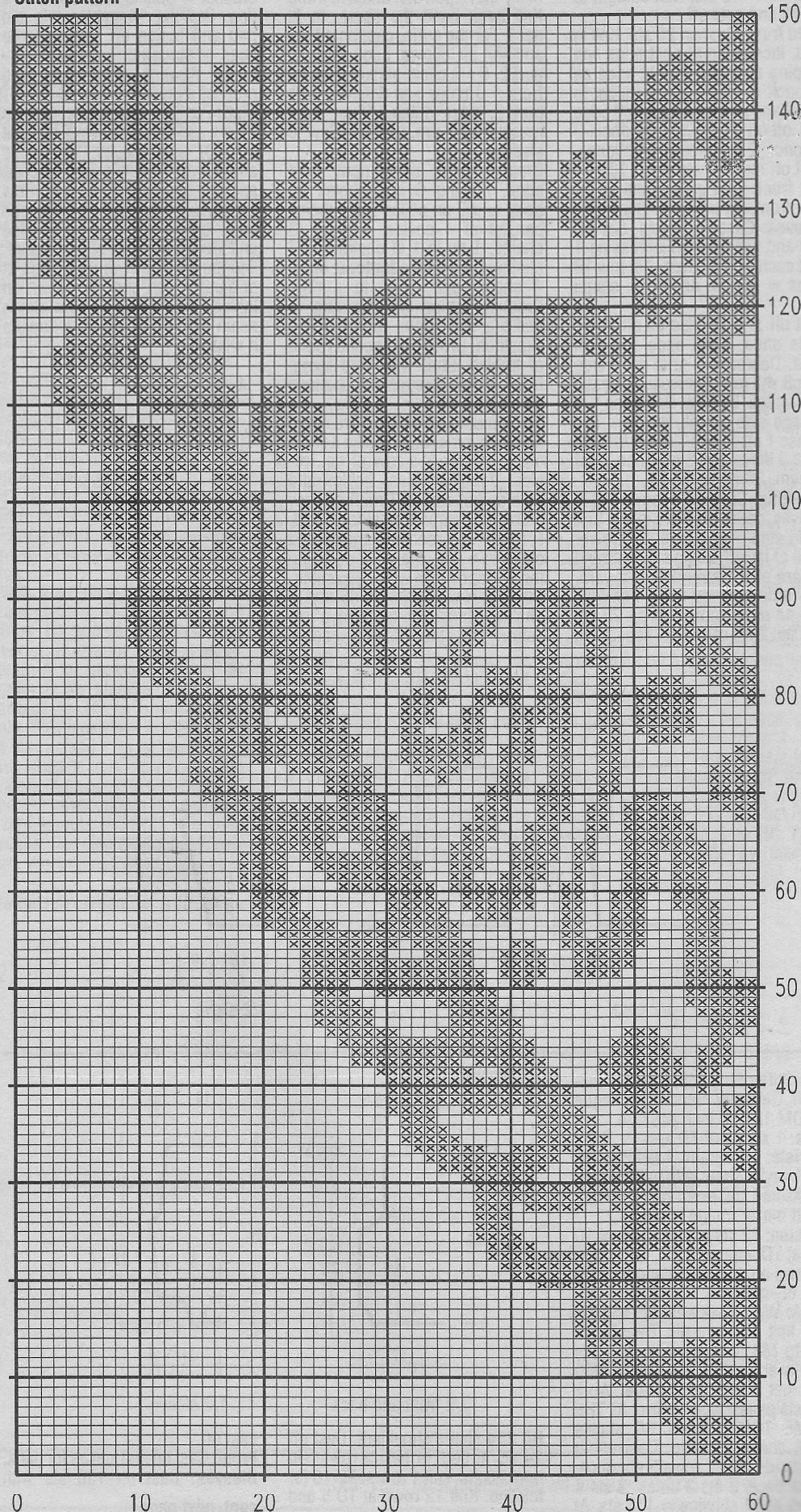

**Size:** 10/12 (14/16). Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge machines with intarsia carriage and ribber. We used a Silver Reed machine.

**Material:** ONLINE Klaus Koch "Zulu" (47% cotton, 53% viscose, 125 m/50 g) approx. 650 (700) g white. "Royal" (70% french angora, 30% lambswool, 33 m/10 g) approx. 10 g black. AUSTERMANN "Suzette" (100% polyester, 175 m/25 g) approx. 25 g silver. Small amount white angora for neck line. 3 mm crochet hook.

Available as a kit from STRICKLIESL H & H Ruhm, Baumeister Specht Str. 6, 8998 Lindenberg im Allgäu, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 90,00 (DM 94,00) incl. postage.

**Ribs:** 1 x 1 rib at TD approx. 3° - 4.

**Intarsia:** Knitted at TD approx. 9°. Use separate balls of yarn for each colour and twist yarns at back when changing colours.

**Tension:** 29 sts and 35 rows = 10 cm at TD 9° with Zulu.

Arrows on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** With white on 146 (158) sts and knit 36 rows rib. Transfer all



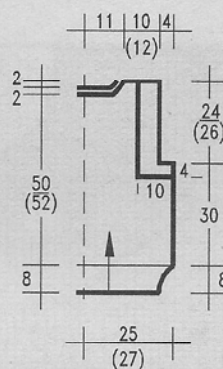
sts to MB and continue in st st. Set RC 000 and knit with white to RC 90. Change to intarsia and knit 30 sts at each side in silver, rem. 86 (98) sts in centre in white. At RC 104, cast off 12 sts at beg. of next 2 rows. Knit in pattern to RC 182 (190) and shape neck. Cast off centre 52 sts and knit each side separately. 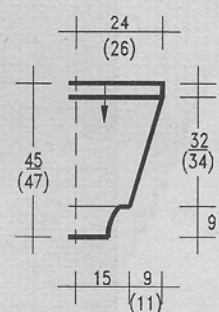
**Sleeves:** E-wrap cast on 140 (152) sts with lurex. Set RC 000

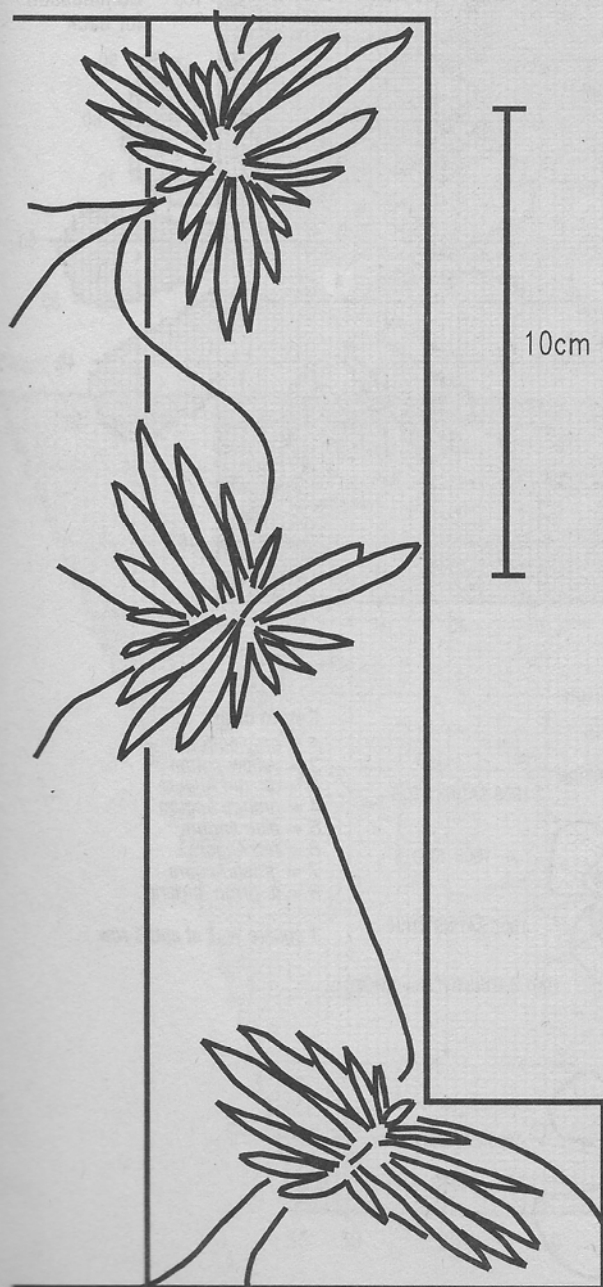

Size: 12 - 16.

**Machines:** Suitable for machines with 7 mm gauge. We used a Singer Double Bed machine.

**Material:** LANA GROSSA "Albia" (100% mercerised cotton, 80 m/50 g) approx. 500 g grey and 350 g yellow. ANNY BLATT "Angora-Super" (70% angora, 30% wool, 106 m/25 g) approx. 25 g each in red, dk.red, orange, blue, green and lt.green.

For the embroidery MADEIRA "Silk" in lt.blue, midblue, dk.blue, red, dk.red, rust, yellow, orange, lt.pink, dk.pink, dk.green and olive green. Use 4 strands throughout. 3, 5 or 4 mm knitting needles for the welts.

**Ribs:** Knit 1, purl 1 rib knitted by hand.

**Intarsia:** Knitted at highest possible tension from charts on following pages. Use separate balls of yarn for each colour and twist yarns at back when changing colour.

**Embroidery:** Follow design chart given.

**Tension:** 21 sts and 30 rows = 10

cm.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Front:** Cast on with waste yarn 120 sts and knit several rows. Set RC 00 and knit from chart 1. At RC 100, mark both side edges for armholes. Knit round neckline as shown on chart. Cast off rem. 42 shoulder sts at RC 192.

**Back:** Cast on and knit as front, reversing the pattern. Work only the grey and yellow areas and the two flowers started on front. Omit rem. leaves and flowers. At RC 192, cast off all stitches loosely.

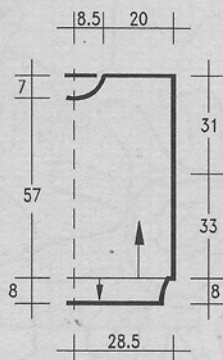
**Left sleeve:** Cast on 70 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit following chart 2, read increases from chart and cast off all sts at RC 110.

**Right sleeve:** Cast on and knit as above, but use chart 3.

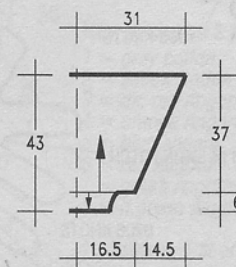
**Welts and cuffs:** For back and front, pick up sts from lower edge and decrease to 110 sts. With grey knit 8 cm in rib and cast off. For cuffs reduce sts to 48. Knit 6 cm in rib and cast off.

**Size:** 12 - 16

**Machines:** We used a Brother KH 270 chunky electronic machine.

Knit to RC 300 and shape back neck. Set carriage for HP, push to HP centre 14 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge push to HP on alt. rows 7 sts twice and 6 sts once. AT THE SAME TIME at RC 300 cast off for shoulder at outside edge 16 sts twice and 17 sts twice. All sts are cast off at RC 308. Repeat shaping on other side. Return 54 sts in centre to WP. Knit several rows waste yarn and release from machine.

**Right front:** Cast on in grey 90 sts and knit 30 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB and set RC 000. Knit in stripe sequence A to RC 162 and mark right edge for armhole. Knit to RC 274 and shape neck. Set carriage for HP. At left edge push to HP on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once and 3 sts twice. Push to HP on every row 2 sts 4 times and 1 st once. At RC 300, shape shoulder at right edge as on back. At RC 308, all sts are cast off. Knit several rows waste yarn over sts in HP and release from machine.

**Left front:** Cast on and knit as for right front, reversing all shapings.

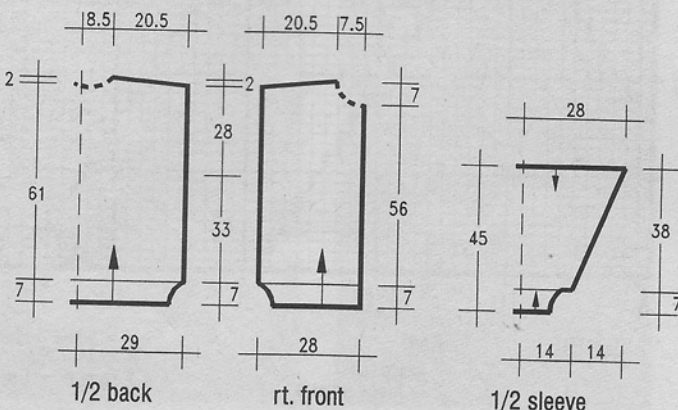
**Neckband:** Close shoulder seams. With grey, cast on 148 sts in rib and knit 30 rows. Transfer all sts to MB. With purl side facing pick up the sts held on waste yarn on back and fronts onto same needles. Pick up extra sts from straight edges. Knit 1 row and cast off. Fold band in half to inside and stitch down.

**Sleeves:** With purl side facing, pick up 180 sts from side edge between markers and hang on needles. Set RC 000 and knit in stripe sequence B. decrease 1 st at each side on every 4th row 44 times = 92 sts. At RC 186, knit several rows waste yarn and release work from machine.

**Cuffs:** With grey cast on 64 sts and knit 30 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB. Pick up sts from lower edge of sleeves and hang on needles. decreasing evenly across the row. Knit 1 row and cast off.

**Button band:** With purl side facing, pick up 199 sts from left front edge and hang on needles. Knit in grey st st at TD 4. Knit 18 rows, knit 1 row at TD 10 and knit 18 rows at TD 4. Cast off. Fold in half to inside and stitch down.

**Buttonhole band:** Pick up sts from right front and knit as above. Make 9 buttonholes on row 9. Space buttonholes approx. 20 sts apart. Finishing: Close all seams. Finish buttonholes. Sew on buttons.

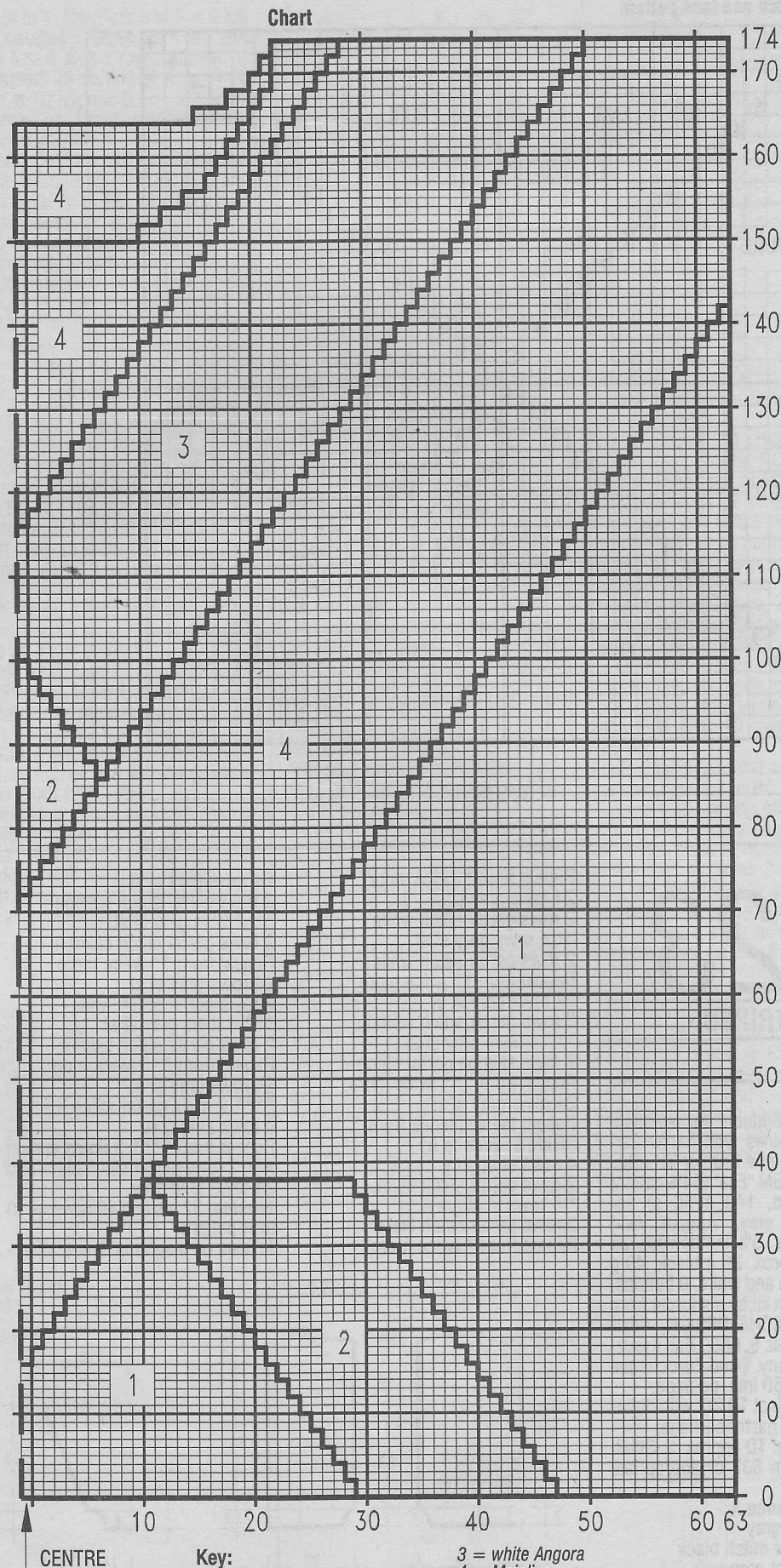
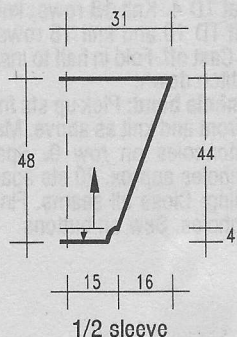
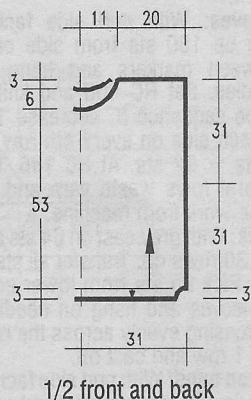

**Ribs:** Knitted by hand. Row 1: Knit 1 through back of loop, purl 1. Row 2: Knit 1, purl 1 through back of loop.

**Intarsia:** Knitted at TD approx. 5. Use separate balls of yarn for each colour and twist yarns at back

when changing colour. For colour arrangement see instructions.

**Tension:** 20 sts and 25 rows = 10 cm.

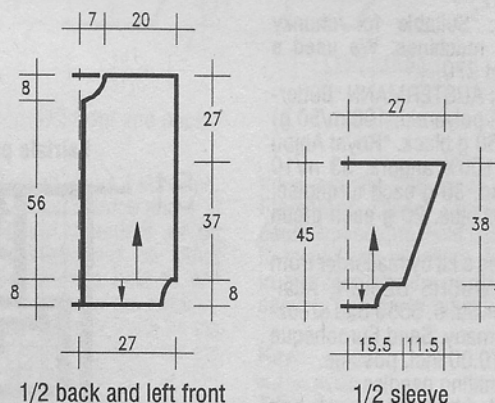
**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

Cast off at right edge 8 sts once. Decrease at right edge on alt. rows 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times. Cast off rem. 41 sts at RC 160.

**Right front:** Cast on and knit as left front, reversing colours and shapings.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 62 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000. Knit in intarsia as follows: Counting from right edge, knit 5 sts red, 26 sts black, 26 sts red and 5 sts black. Reverse colours after 16 rows and then after every foll. 40 rows. AT THE SAME TIME, increase 1 sts at each side



on every 4th row 23 times = 108 sts. At RC 96, cast off all stitches.

**Welts:** Pick up sts from lower edge of back. Reduce to 98 sts and knit 8 cm in rib as given. Pick up sts from fronts, reducing them to 48 sts and knit as for back welt. For the cuffs, pick up the sts from the lower edge of the sleeves and reduce them to 48 sts. Knit 7 cm in rib and cast off.

**Front bands:** Pick up 170 sts from straight front edges. Knit 2.5 cm in rib and cast off. On right front band, work 9 buttonholes at 1.25 cm height.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder seams. Pick up approx. 110 sts around neckline, including front bands. Knit 2.5 cm rib and cast off. Set in sleeves between markers, matching the squares. Close side and sleeve seams. Sew on appliques and buttons.

### ANGORA SWEATER

**Size:** 10/12

**Machines:** Suitable for chunky electronic machines. We used a Brother KH 270.

**Materials:** AUSTERMANN "Butterfly" (100% polyamid, 100 m/50 g) approx. 550 g black. "Royal Anjou Angora" (100% angora, 33 m/10 g) 40 g red, 30 g each turquoise, yellow and blue. 20 g each green and purple.

Available as a kit by mailorder from JUTTA HINRICHS DESIGN, Adalbert-Stifter Str. 5, 6550 Bad Kreuznach, Germany. Send Eurocheque for DM 279.00 incl. postage. 3.5 mm knitting needles.

**Ribs:** Knitted by hand. Row 1: Knit 1 through back of loop, purl 1. Row 2: Knit 1, purl 1 through back of loop.

**Fairisle pattern:** Program machine with pattern over 23 sts and 51 rows. Knit at TD 1. Work rows 1 - 51 with colours as given, work rows 52 - 102 with colours in brackets.

**Tension:** 24.5 sts 25.5 rows = 10 cm over fairisle.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

**Back:** Cast on 114 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and continue in pattern to RC 34. Shape armholes. Cast off at each side on alt. rows 6 sts once, 5 sts twice, 3 sts once, 2 sts once and 1 st once = 70 sts. Knit in pattern to RC 102 and cast off.

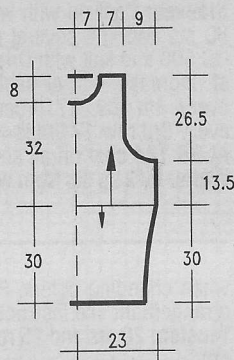
**Front:** Cast on and knit as for back to RC 82. Shape front neck. Cast off centre 24 sts and knit each side separately. At neck edge cast off on alt. rows 2 sts once and 1 st 3 times. Cast off remaining 18 sts at RC 102.

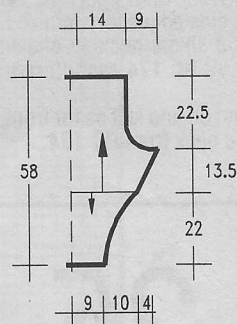

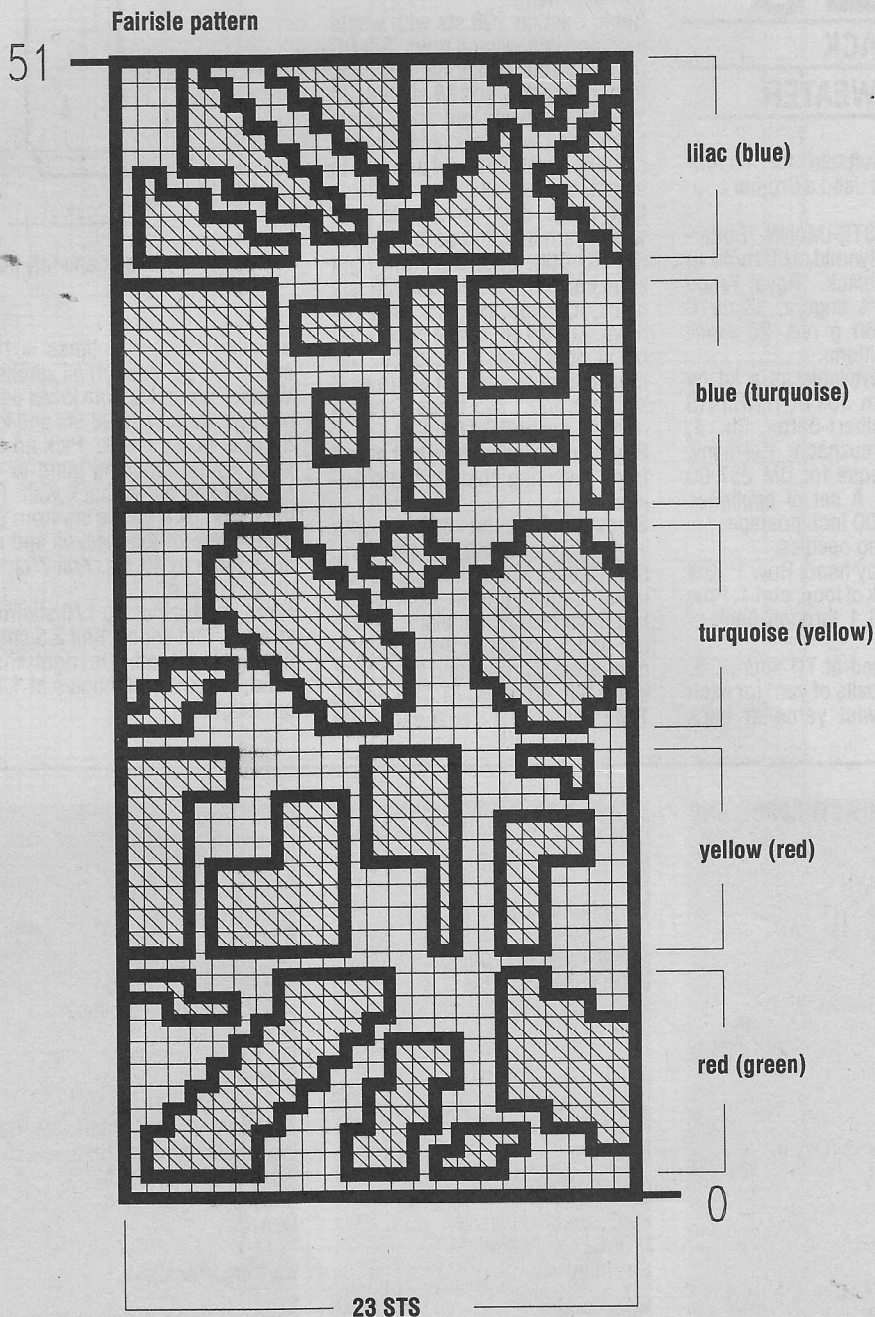

**Materials:** KKK "Zulu" (47% cotton, 53% viscose, 125 m/50 g) approx. 700 (750) g white. Small amounts of beige, cream red, black, blue, green and brown. For the eyes 2 small stones, various flowers to sew on, 2 sequin butterflies. Lurex thread for the parcel string.

**Ribs:** 1 x 1 rib at TD approx. 3 - 4

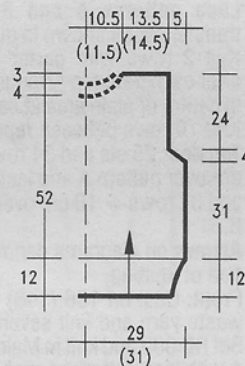
**Intarsia:** Knitted from the chart. Use separate balls of yarn for each colour and twist yarns at back when changing colours. Smaller areas may be swiss-darned. The parcel is embroidered in green satin stitch with the string in Lurex.

**Tension:** 29 sts and 34 35 rows = 10 cm at TD approx. 9°.

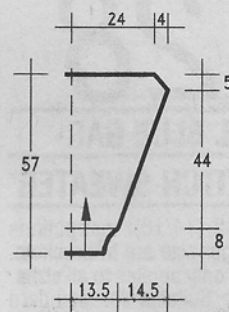

**Front:** Cast on and knit welt as for back. Start intarsia on row 1 and continue in st st when pattern ends. Shape neck at **RC 180**. Set carriage for HP. Push to HP centre 24 (30) sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge

Decrease 1 st fully-fashioned at each side on rows 2, 3, 5, 6, 8, 9, 11, 12, 14, 15, 17 and 18. Cast off

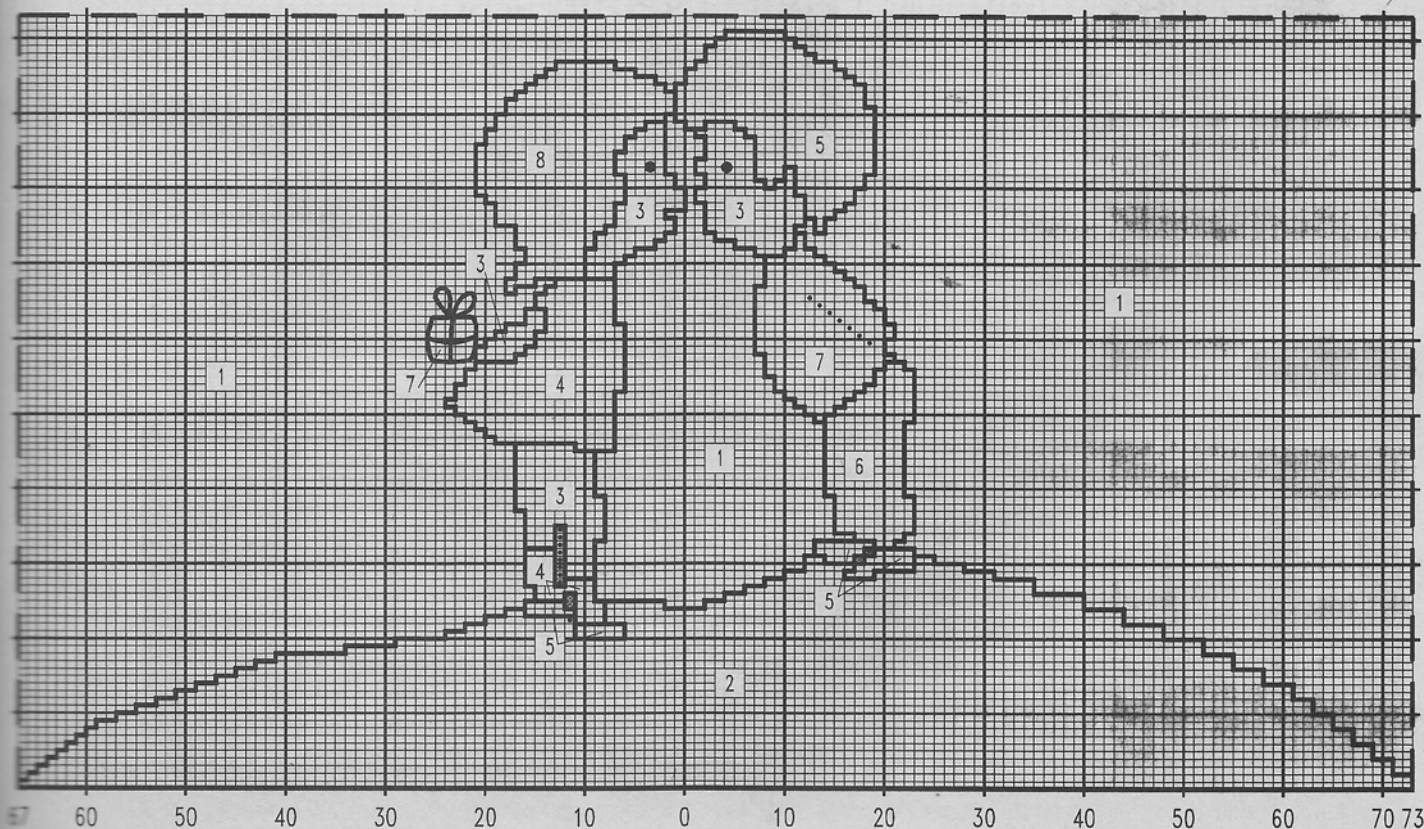

**Size:** 10/12 (14/16). Instructions for the larger size are in brackets. One figure only applies to all sizes.

**Machines:** Suitable for standard gauge electronic machines with more than 60 stitch pattern repeat and garter carriage. We used a Brother KH 930.

**Materials:** JUNGHANS "Holiday" (60% cotton, 40% superwash wool, 290 m/100 g) approx. 550 (600) g petrol blue.

**Cable ribs:** Program Stitch World Pattern 533 with switch 3 UP - double width. Knit with garter carriage at TD 8. On every 4th row cable the 4 purl sts always in the same direction.

**Main Pattern A:** Program machine as in chart A over 65 sts and 24 rows. Knit as Single Motif in centre. TD approx. 10.

**Main Pattern B:** Program over 5 sts and 8 rows as overall pattern.

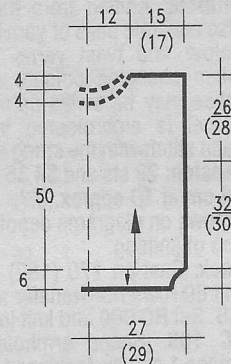
**Lace patterns A and B:** Hand-transfer sts as shown in diagrams. Knit 2 rows with garter carriage after each transfer. Arrange pattern in centre of plain area at each side. Knit 10 rows between repeats.

**Tension:** 25 sts and 34 rows = 10 cm over pattern A and lace. 26 sts and 34 rows = 10 cm over pattern B.

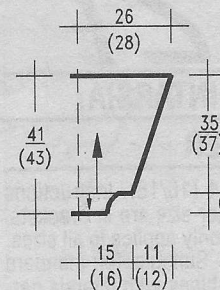

**Front:** Cast on 136 (146) sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit in Main pattern A with lace pattern at each side. At **RC 110 (102)** mark side edges for armholes. At **RC 170** shape neck. Take back to NWP on nylon cord centre 16 sts and all sts at side opposite to carriage. At neck edge take to NWP on alt. rows 5 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts once, 2 sts once, 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 3 times and 1 st once. Cast off the rem. 38 (43) shoulder sts at **RC 198**. Repeat shaping on other side. Return needles from NWP to WP. Pick up 10 sts at each side from straight edges. Knit 1 row. Knit **neckband** in cable pattern for 14 rows and cast off.

**Back:** Cast on and knit as for front but with higher neckline. Knit to **RC 184** and shape neck. Take to NWP with nylon cord centre 24 sts and

**Welts:** Reducing number of sts on back or front to 128, hang sts on needles. Knit 1 row. Set garter carriage for cable rib and knit 28 rows. Cast off.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 78 (84) sts with waste yarn and knit several rows.

Set RC 000 and continue in Main Pattern B. Increase 1 st at each side on every 4th row 29 (31) times = 136 (146) sts. At **RC 118 (126)** cast off all stitches.

**Cuffs:** Pick up sts from lower edge of sleeve and hang on 62 needles. Knit 1 row. Knit 28 rows cable rib and cast off.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder and neck band seams. Set in sleeves between markers. Close remaining seams.

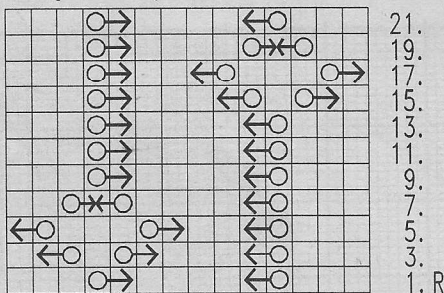

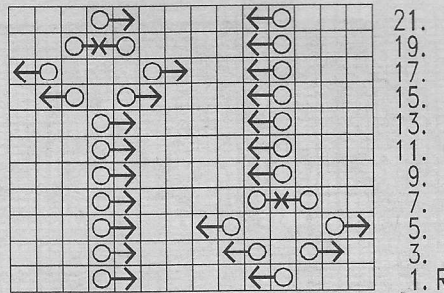

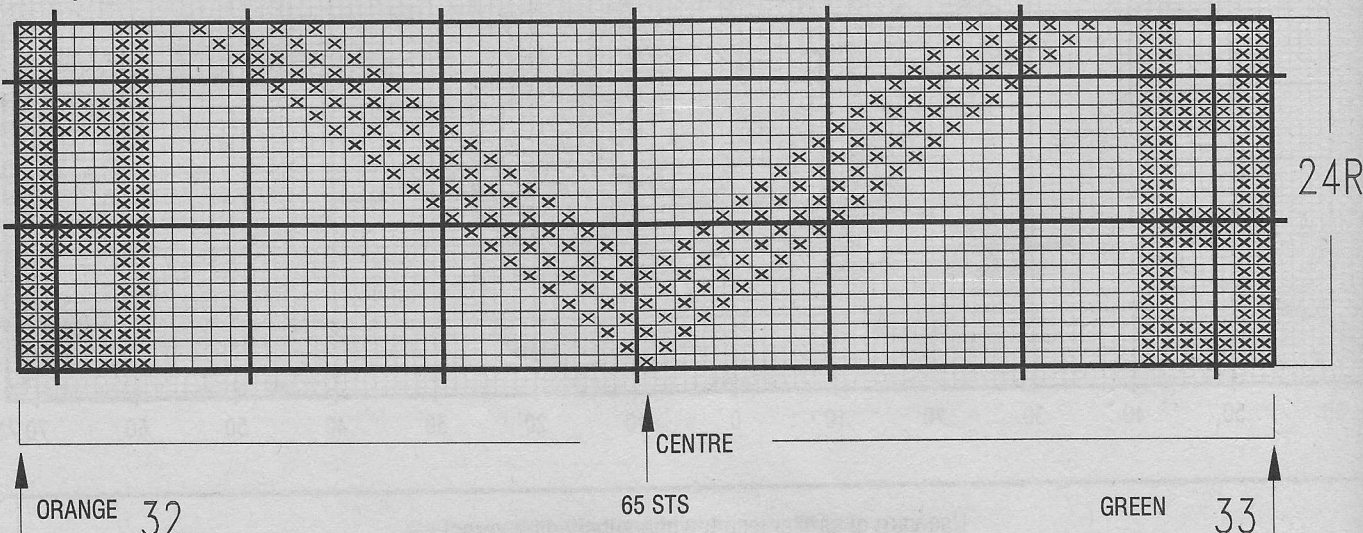

**Intarsia:** Knittes from charts 1 and 2 at TD approx. 6". Use separate balls of yarn for each colour and twist yarns at back when changing colours.

**Tension:** 17 - 18 and 24 rows = 10 cm.

**Arrows** on diagrams denote direction of knitting.

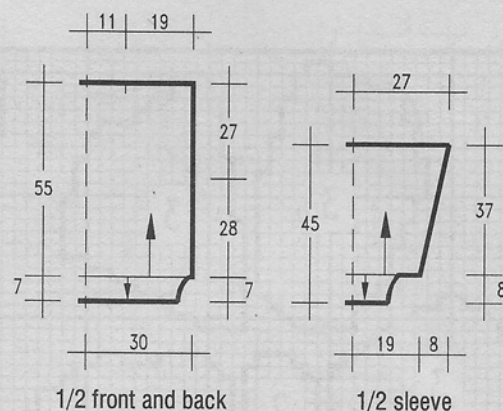
**Front:** Cast on 106 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit from chart 1. At RC 68 mark both side edges for armholes. Knit to RC 132 and cast off all sts loosely.

**Back:** Cast on and knit as for front, reversing the pattern.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 66 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit from chart 2. Increase at each side as shown on chart. At RC 90 cast off all 94 sts.

**Cuffs:** Pick up sts from lower edge



of sleeves. Reduce to 48 sts. Knit 7 cm in rib with Lucciola and 1 cm rib with yellow angora. Cast off.

**Finishing:** Close shoulder seams, leaving the centre 22 cm open for the neck. Crochet around neckline with yellow angora 1 row dc's and 1 row crab stitch. Set in sleeves between markers. Close side and sleeve seams.

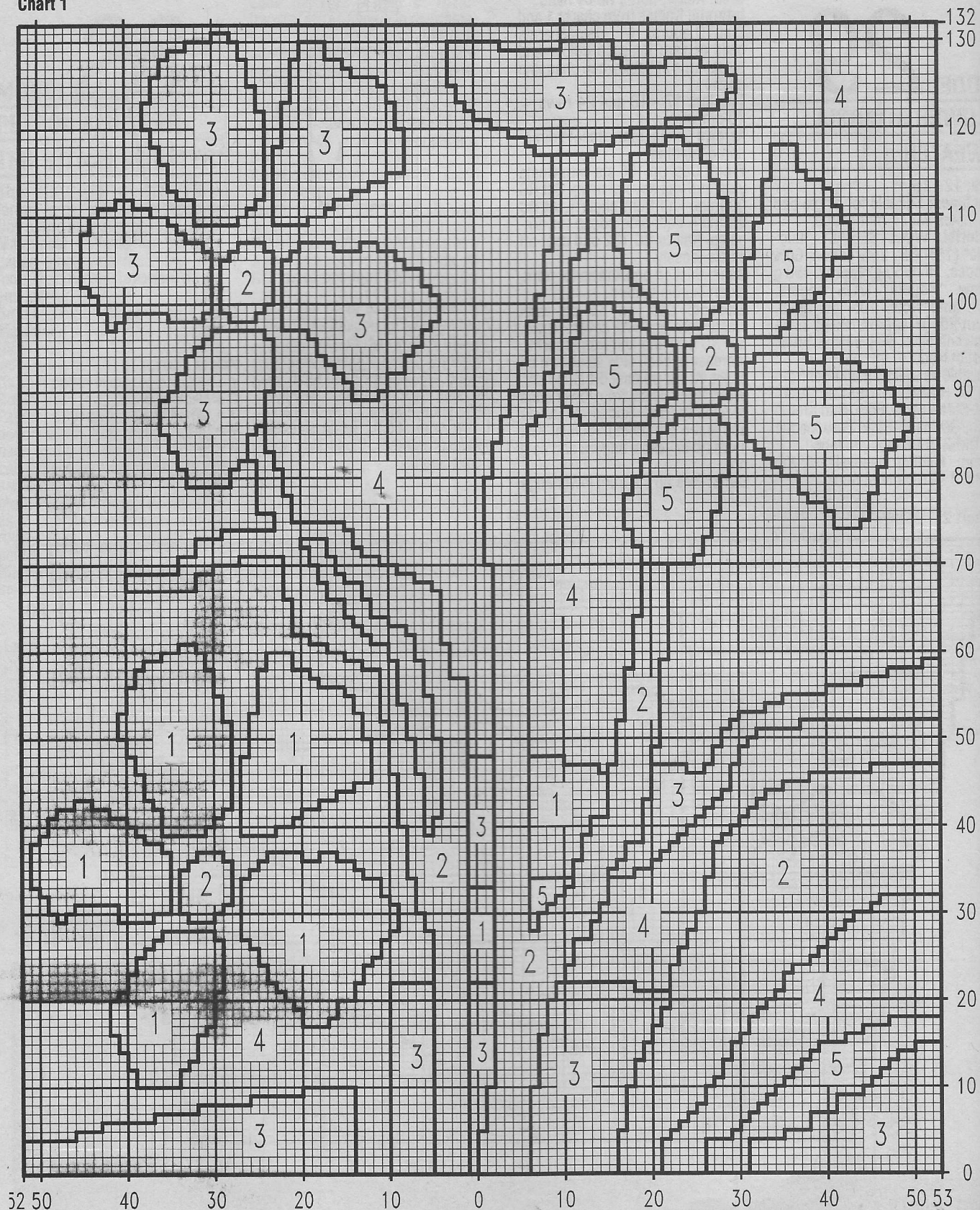

Knit 30 rows in pattern and mark stitch 21 at left and right of centre with contrast yarn. Knit a further 30 rows. Knit 1 row contrast. Knit 10 rows pattern. Remove knitting from machine and pull lengthwise. Let knitting rest for several hours. With the Knitmaster "Green for standard gauge or "Blue" ruler for chunky machines, determine the number of stitches and rows between the marks of contrast yarn. If they do not agree with the tensions given, adjust the settings, knit a different size or work out the number of stitches needed for the garment.

"Gold & Silver" (65% polyamid, 35% met. polyester, 260 m/100 g) approx. 75 (100) g gold. "Angora Royal" (70% angora, 30% wool, 485 m/100 g) approx. 125 (150) g black. 3 or 3.5 mm crochet hook.

**Ribs:** 2 x 2 rib at TD approx. 7/7.

**Fairisle pattern:** Program machine according to the charts. For punchcard machines adjust pattern B. Knit all patterns at TD approx. 10°.

**Tension:** 26 - 27 sts and 33 - 34 rows = 10 cm over fairisle pattern.

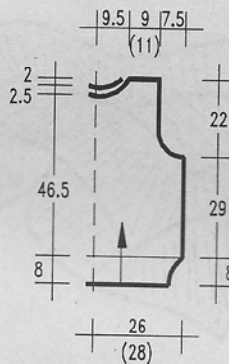

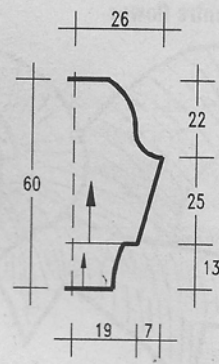

Knit 18 rows dk. yellow st st. Knit 4 rows lt. yellow st st. Knit 11 rows pattern C lt. yellow/gold. Knit 6 rows st st lt. yellow. Knit 14 rows pattern D lt. yellow/gold. Knit 22 rows lt. yellow st st. AT THE SAME TIME when RC shows 96, shape armholes. Cast off at each side on alternate rows 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 4 times and 1 st twice = 100 (110) sts. Knit straight to RC 164 and shape back neck. Cast off centre 32 sts and knit each side separately. At neck edge cast off on alt. rows 5 sts twice. Cast off rem. 24 (29) sts at RC 171.

**Front:** Cast on and knit in pattern as for back to RC 156. Shape neck. Cast off centre 18 sts and knit each side separately. Cast off at neck edge on alt. rows 3 sts 4 times, 2 sts twice and 1 st once. Cast off shoulder sts at RC 171.

**Sleeves:** Cast on 104 sts with waste yarn and knit several rows. Set RC 000 and knit in pattern as

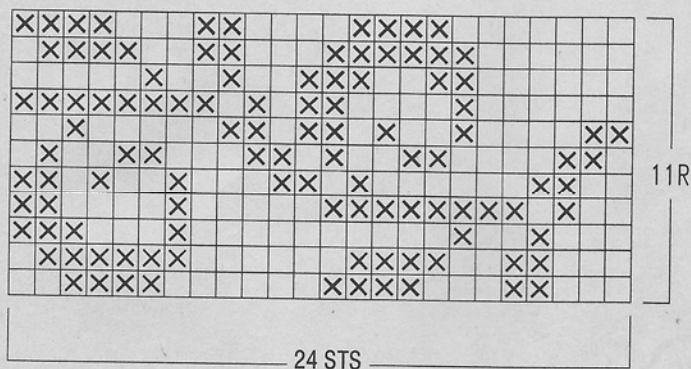
on back, But knit only 54 rows black st st! Increase 1 st at each side on every 4th row 17 times = 138 sts. At RC 84 shape top. Cast off at each side on alt. rows 4 sts once, 3 sts twice, 2 sts 4 times and 1 st twice = 98 sts. Knit straight to RC 140. Cast off at each side on alt. rows 1 st 3 times, 2 sts 3 times, 3 sts twice and 4 sts once. Cast off rem. 60 sts at RC 159.

**Cuffs:** Cast on with dark yellow 54 sts and knit 46 rows rib. Transfer all sts to MB. Pick up open sts from bottom of sleeve and hang on needles, decreasing evenly across the row. Knit 1 row and cast off.

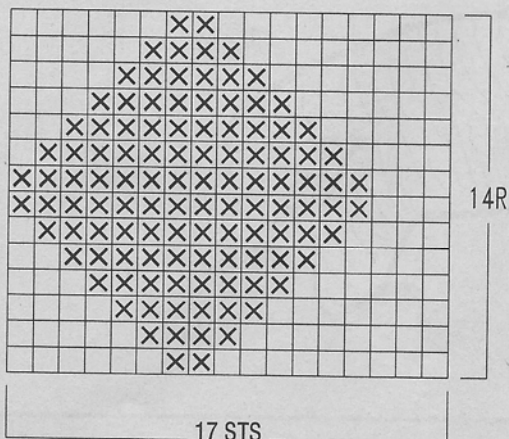
**Finishing:** Embroider the front as

shown. Close all seams. Set in sleeves, gathering top to fit. With light yellow, crochet around neckline 1 row dc's and 1 row crab-stitch.

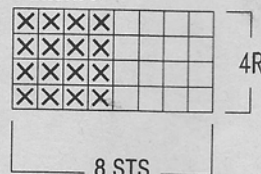

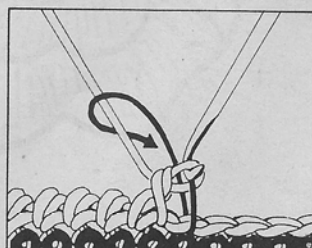

CRAB STITCH

For neater edges on knitted or crochet garments:

Work with crochet hook in direction of narrow. Push hook through stitch on previous row. Pull yarn through and then pull yarn through both loops on hook.

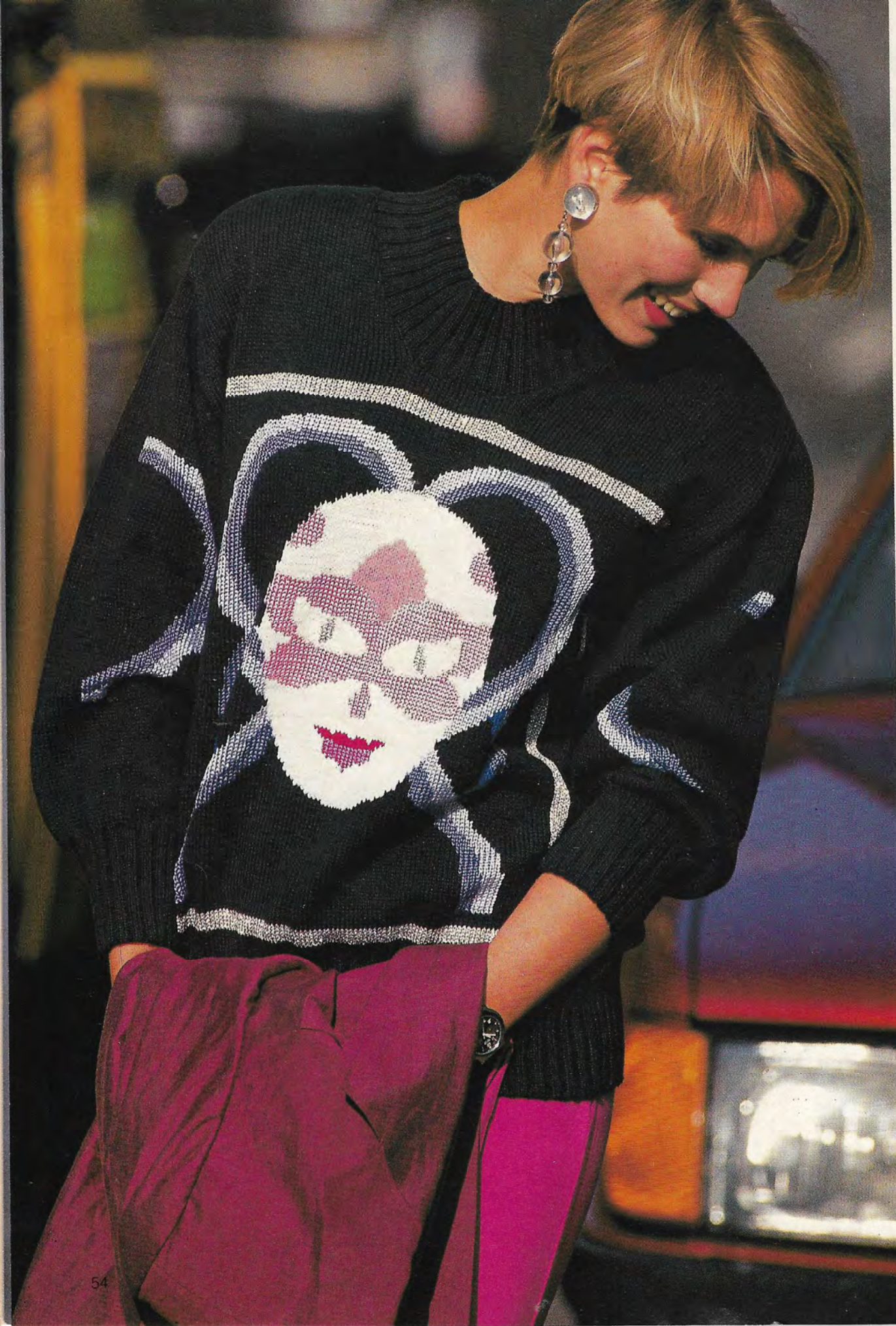

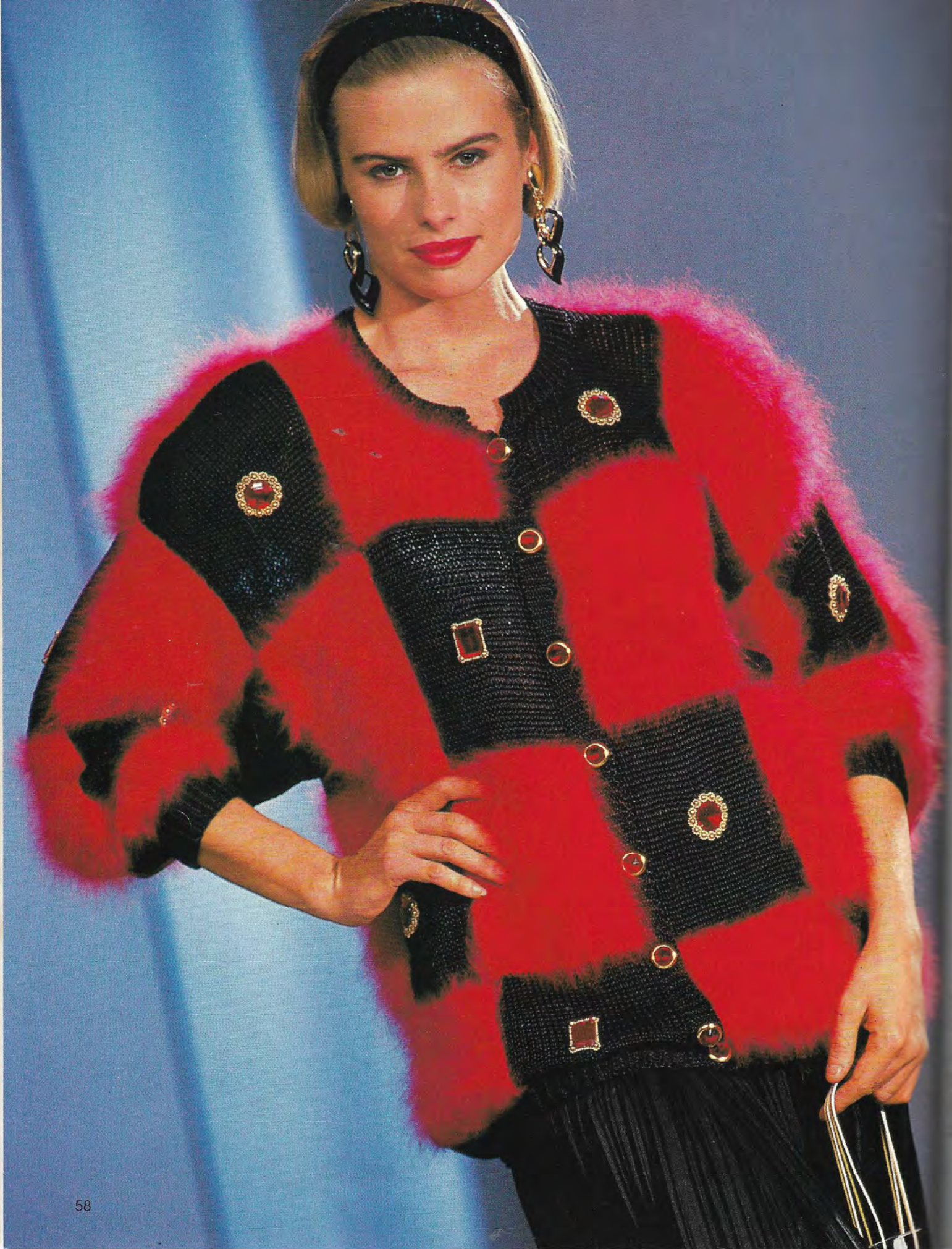
