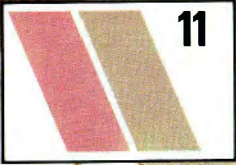


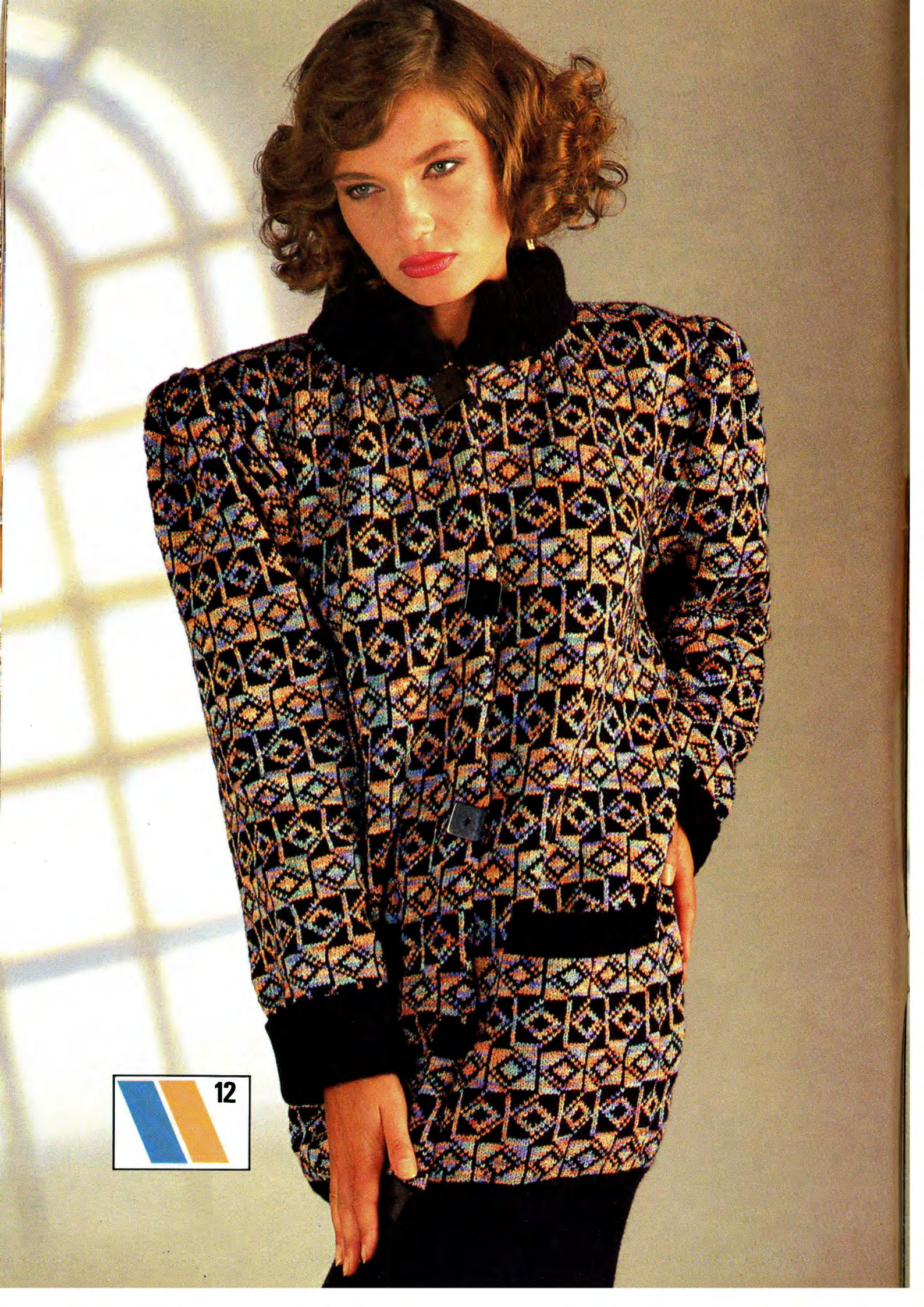






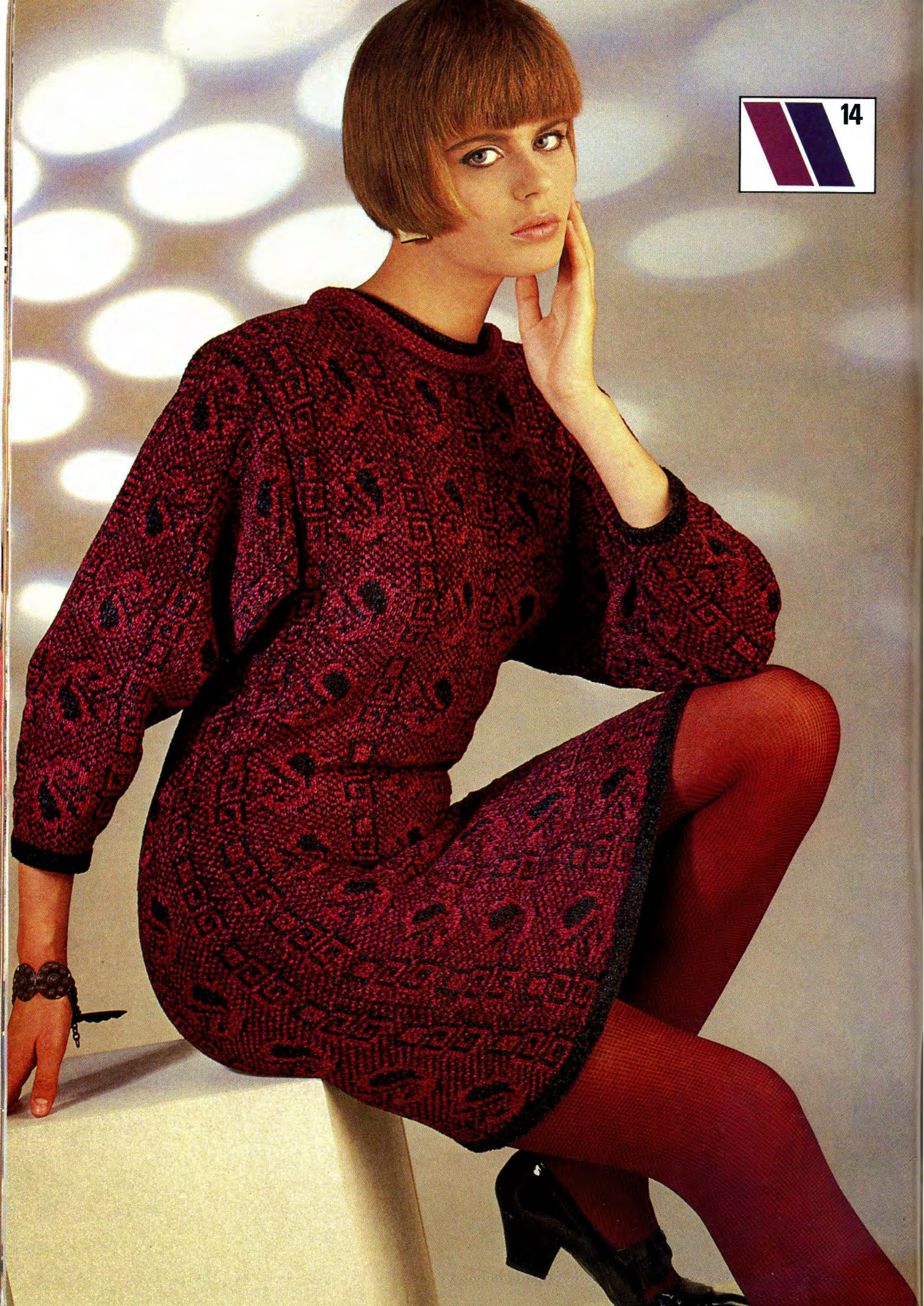






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Fashion is Knitwear

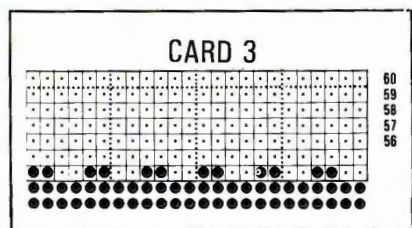
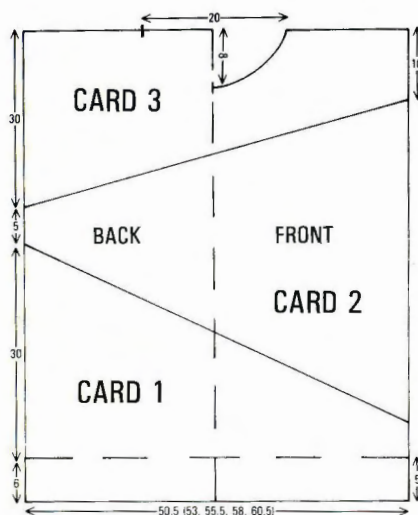
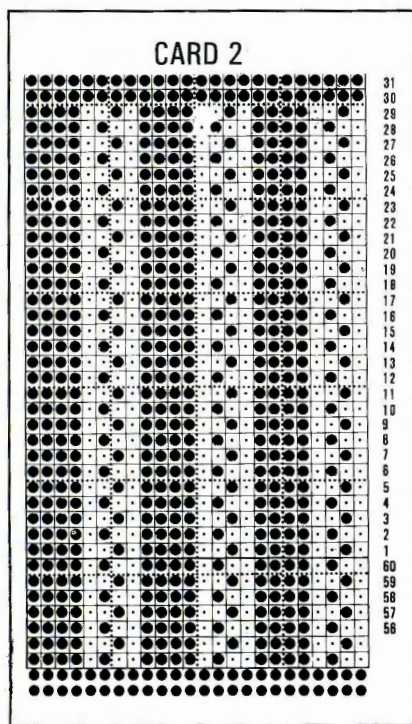
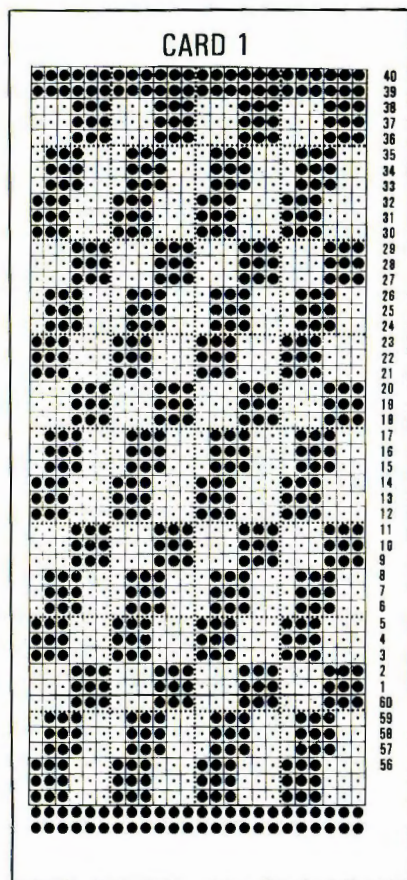


FAIRISLE SWEATER

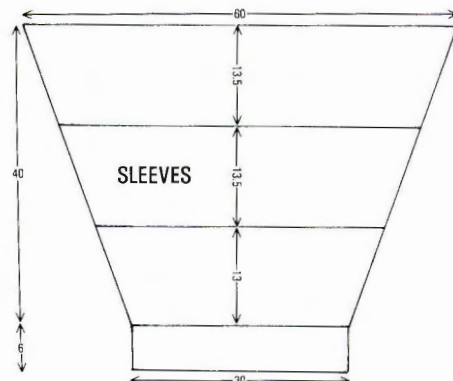
MACHINE: E + KL. **MATERIALS:** SUNBEAM The Paris Mohair Collection: M—225 (250, 275, 300, 325) g (Peach Pearl 6904). SUNBEAM Paris Luxury Mohair: A—150 (175, 200, 225, 250) g (Moonshine 6922), B & C—75 (100, 125, 150, 175) g (Pink Sheen 6913 and C Fiord 6929). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Card 1—with B in FA and A in FB: 20 sts = 13 cm and 30 rows = 13.5 cm (approx T10). Card 2—with C in FA and M in FB cable 2 over 2 on C only, every 6 rows: 20 sts = 13 cm and 30 rows = 13.8 cm (approx T10). Card 3—with A in FA and M in FB knit 6 rows, knit 1 row A only (card 3 is locked on row 1 throughout): 20 sts = 13 cm and 30 rows = 12.7 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** T0, cast on required number of sts over every N and knit required number of rows. Drop every alt st, ladder to first row knitted then latch up the last row knitted, placing st back onto N. Place WY markers as shown on diagram.

BACK/FRONT

Draw complete diagram onto sheet. Using M cast on required number of sts and work 20 rows rib. Insert Card 1, set KL accordingly and work patt as given under TENSION to beg of first diagonal line. As sheet moves down, push Ns along diagonal line to HP. When all Ns are in HP... *Using M knit 6



rows over all Ns. Pick up sts from first row knitted in M and place onto Ns. Knit 1 row. * Return all Ns to HP. Insert Card 2, reset KL and move sheet back to beg of first diagonal line. Working patt, return Ns on the opposite side—to return work to the horizontal—to WP as they appear along the first diagonal line. Work to second diagonal line and push Ns into HP as they appear along it. Using the method as given, complete BACK/FRONT. Waste knit shoulder sts. **Neckband:** Join one shoulder by placing both sets of shoulder sts, right sides together, onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Pick up 75 sts along neck edge. T2 using M knit 18 rows as rib. Knit 1 row and waste knit. Join second shoulder as first.

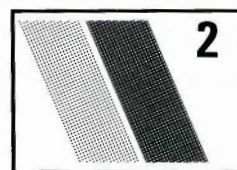


SLEEVES

Draw sleeve diagram onto sheet. Pick up sts between WY markers and cont as method for BACK/FRONT, at horizontal line rep from * to *. **Cuff:** Work 20 rows rib and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join neckband seam, fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Join underarm and side seams.



SKINNY RIB WITH SADDLE SLEEVES

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** ARGYLL Laser Acrylic 4 ply: M—350 (375, 400, 425, 450) g. Colours illustrated: Cerise 569 (pink) and Peacock 572 (green/blue). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** 2×2 rib: 40 sts = 12.2 cm and 60 rows = 16.4 cm. Pitch lever to H (approx T6/6).

NOTES: Only Ns on KH are counted when shaping.

BACK

Using M cast on 137 (143, 152, 161, 170) sts as rib, 000. T4/4 knit to RC30, 000. T6/6 knit to RC100, 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit 4 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 0 (0, 0, 6, 10), then every foll 5th row × 8 (4, 8, 10, 8) and every foll 6th row × 4 (8, 5, 0, 0). Knit to RC70 (74, 78, 80, 84). Waste knit centre 47 (47, 52, 51, 56) sts. Waste knit rem 30 (33, 34, 36, 36) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

As BACK to RC60 (64, 66, 70, 74) above armhole shaping, COR.

Neck shaping

Push centre 23 (23, 28, 27, 32) Ns to HP. Waste knit sts at left, COR. *Knit 2 rows. At neck edge push 3 Ns into HP. * Rep from * to * 3 times more. Knit to RC70 (74, 78, 80, 84) and waste knit. Replace sts from left

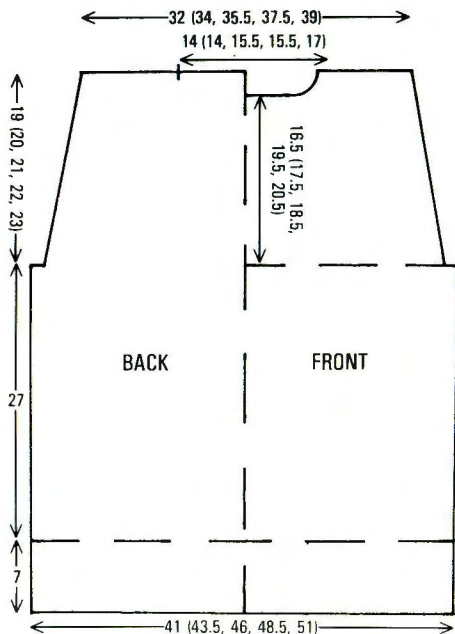
side back onto Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using M cast on 68 (68, 71, 71, 74) sts as rib, 000. T4/4 knit to RC30, 000. T6/6 knit to RC6. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6th row \times 18 (18, 19, 19, 19)—104 (104, 109, 109, 112) sts. Knit to RC132. 000.

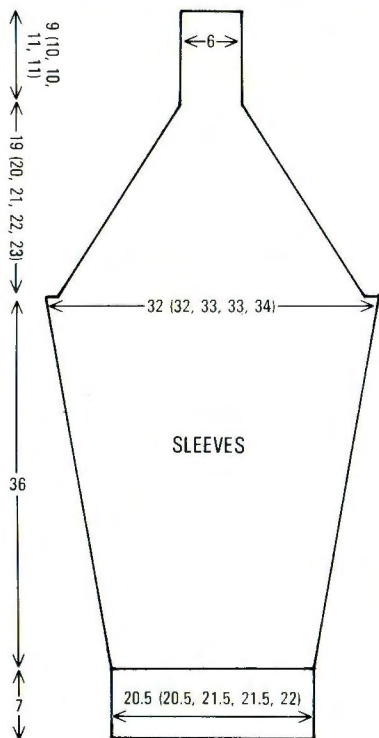
Raglan and saddle shaping

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row \times 31 (35, 35, 39, 41), then every row \times 8 (4, 6, 2, 2). Knit to RC102 (110, 114, 120, 124) and waste knit rem 20 (20, 21, 21, 20) sts.



POLO NECKBAND AND MAKE-UP

With wrong side facing, pick up 128 (128, 134, 134, 137) sts evenly along neck edge. Trans to rib, 000. T5/5 knit to RC80 and cast off loosely. Join all 4 saddle seams to back/front by placing one shoulder back

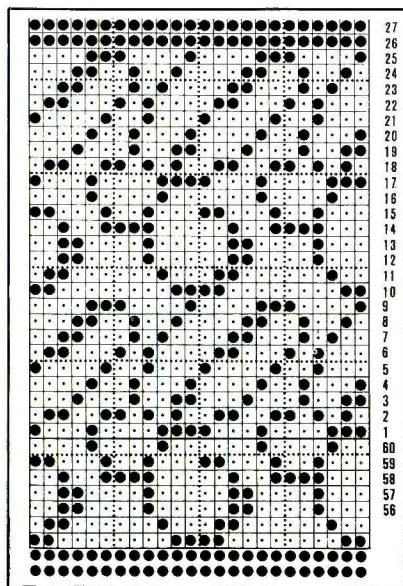


onto Ns (4 sts to 3 Ns) then pick up sts along saddle edge to match. Using M, T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Join raglan seams, then side, sleeve and neckband seams.

V-NECK OVERTOP

MACHINES: A or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** ARGYLL Laser Acrylic 4 ply: M—275 (300, 325, 350, 375) g (Black 561), Con Col—175 (200, 225, 250, 275) g (White 560). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle: 40 sts = 12.4 cm and 60 rows = 15.7 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 2 \times 2 Pitch lever to H T5/5.

NOTES: Count Ns on KH only.



BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 161 (171, 179, 185, 195) sts as rib and knit to RC110. Trans to KH, 000. With Con Col in FA and M in FB, release card, T7, and work in fairisle to *RC140 (144, 148, 152, 156), 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 10 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC84.

Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Waste knit centre 69 sts. Waste knit sts to left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and every row dec 1 st \times 7. Knit to RC92 and waste knit. Reset card, return sts at left to Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

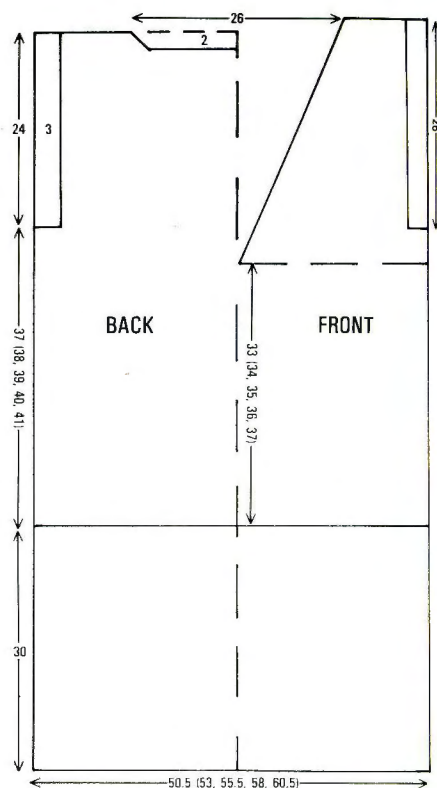
As BACK to *, RC124 (128, 132, 136, 140).

Neck shaping

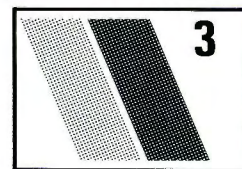
(Note card position.) Trans centre st to adjacent N. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 2 rows. Dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll alt row \times 13, then every 3rd row \times 28. AT THE SAME TIME at RC140 (144, 148, 152, 156), 000, shape armhole as BACK. Knit to RC98 and waste knit. Reset card, return sts at left to Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

MAKE-UP

Block and press lightly fairisle section only.



Neckband: Using M cast on 179 sts as rib. T4/4 knit 28 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing pick up 96 sts along one side of front neck edge and 83 sts from back neck and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Using M cast on 95 sts as rib. T4/4 knit 28 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, pick up 95 sts from second side of front neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Armbands:** Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Using M cast on 149 sts as rib. T4/4 knit 12 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts from armhole edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Join end of armbands to armhole. Cast off. Join neckband seams. Mitre centre front. Join side seams.

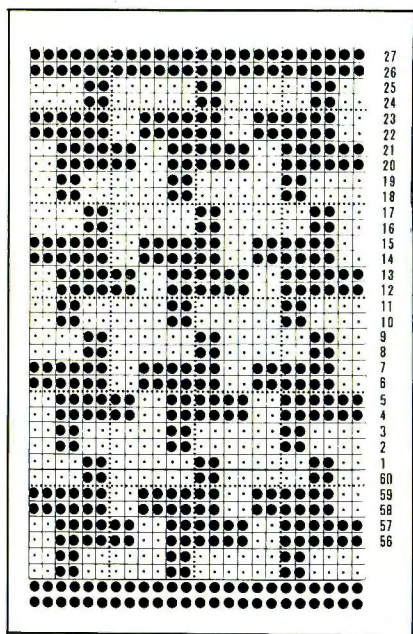


OVERTOP

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** ARGYLL Laser Acrylic 4 ply: M—200 (250, 275, 300, 350) g (Black 561), Con Col—160 (180, 200, 220, 240) g (White 560). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle: 40 sts = 13.3 cm and 60 rows = 15.1 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 2 \times 2 T5/5, Pitch lever to H. Count Ns on KH only.

BACK

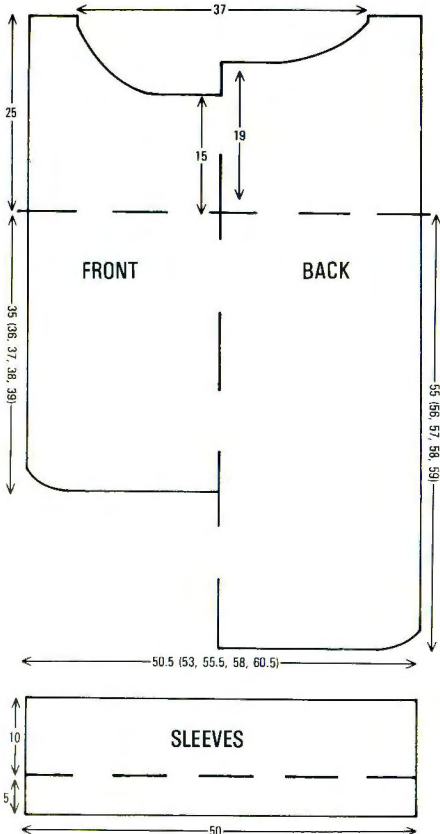
Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M, COBH 152 (159, 166, 174, 181) sts. Set K-carr to KC to select Ns. T7 knit 1 row, 000. With M in FA and Con Col in FB, release card and work in fairisle. *On side opposite K-carr



push 15 Ns into HP, knit 1 row.* Rep from * to *. On next and every foll row, on side opposite K-carr take back to WP 3 inside Ns until all Ns are in WP. Knit to RC220 (224, 228, 232, 236). Using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC76.

Neck shaping

Note card position. Waste knit centre 44 (45, 44, 44, 45) sts. Waste knit sts to left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and every alt row cast off 6 sts \times 1, 5 sts \times 4, 2 sts \times 3, 1 st \times 1. Knit to RC100 and waste knit. Replace 21 (24, 28, 32, 35) sts at left back onto Ns, reset card, and knit to match right side, reversing shapings. *Neckband:* Using M cast on 119 sts and rib (see RIB) 20 rows. Trans sts to



KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

FRONT

As BACK to RC136 (140, 144, 148, 152). Using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC60.

Neck shaping

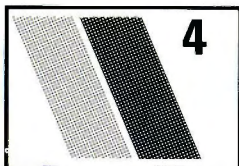
Note card position. Waste knit centre 56 (57, 56, 56, 57) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 4 sts \times 2, 3 sts \times 2, 2 sts \times 4 and 1 st \times 5. Knit to RC100 and waste knit. Reset card, replace sts at left back onto Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings. *Neckband:* Using M cast on 137 sts as rib (see RIB) and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, pick up sts along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Using M cast on 149 sts and rib 20 rows (see RIB). Trans to KH, 000. T7 release card and work in fairisle to RC40. Waste knit, turn work and replace sts onto Ns. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from armhole edge between markers and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Block and press lightly. Join side and sleeve seams. Join neckband. Work 2 rows of crochet around hem. Give final press.



SWEATER WITH LACE INSET

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** SILVERKNIT Dakota: M—240 (250, 260, 270, 280) g (shade 6201). Small amount of lace fabric, velvet ribbon, pearl and glass beads, shoulder pads. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** St st: 40 sts = 12.1 cm and 60 rows = 12.5 cm (approx T3). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T0/0 Slide Lever II.

NOTES: Use FRONT diagram for BACK and FRONT.

FRONT

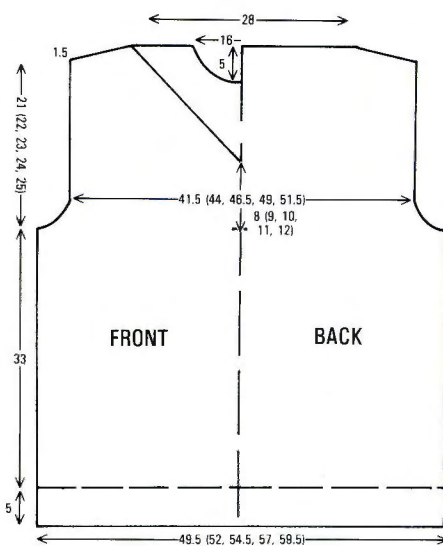
Using M cast on 165 (173, 181, 189, 197) sts as 1 \times 1 rib and knit 30 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T3 knit 158 rows, 000.

Armhole shaping

At beg of next and every row, cast off 4 sts \times 2, 3 sts \times 2, 2 sts \times 2, then dec 1 st at each end of alt rows \times 4. 139 (147, 155, 163, 171) sts rem.** Knit to RC38 (44, 48, 54, 58).

Neck shaping

Dec centre st. Waste knit sts at left. Knit 2 rows. At neck edge on next and every foll



3rd row, dec 2sts \times 22, AT THE SAME TIME at RC100 (106, 110, 116, 120), COR...

Shoulder shaping

At beg of next and alt rows cast off 6 (7, 8, 9, 10) sts \times 3, then cast off rem 7 (8, 9, 10, 11) sts. Place sts at left back onto Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

BACK

As FRONT to **. Knit to RC72 (78, 82, 88, 92).

Neck opening and shoulder shaping

Dec 1 st at centre. Waste knit sts at left. Knit to RC100 (106, 110, 116, 120), COR. Rep from * to *.

SLEEVES

Sections A (see diagram)

Using WY cast on 28 (31, 34, 37, 40) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR. Change to M, T3, 000. Knit 20 rows. Inc 1 st at right edge on next and every foll 20th row \times 10. With the 38 (41, 44, 47, 50) sts knit to RC216, COR, 000.

Sleeve head shaping

At beg of next and alt rows cast off 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) sts \times 1, 2 (4, 6, 8, 10) sts \times 1, 2 sts \times 1, 1 st \times 4, 1 st every 4th row \times 12, 1 st every alt row \times 12, cast off rem st. Knit a second section to match, reversing shapings.

Sections B (see diagram)

Using WY cast on 16 sts and knit a few rows ending with COR, 000. Change to M, T3 knit to RC302, COR. *At beg of next row cast off 2 sts, knit 1 row*, rep from * to * \times 4. Knit to RC312 and cast off. Knit a second section to match, reversing shapings.

Sections C (see diagram)

Using WY cast on 16 sts and knit a few rows ending with COR, 000. Change to M, T3 knit to RC312 and cast off.

Cuffs

Push 85 (89, 93, 95, 99) Ns into WP. With wrong side facing replace sts from cuff edge onto Ns, distributing them evenly along the row. T3 knit 1 row, 000. Trans to rib, knit to RC60 and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Block and press lightly all pieces. Join sleeve sections at sleeve head 1 cm from top. Join shoulder seams, set in sleeves gathering sleeve head to fit. Join underarm and side seams. Attach beads, catching sleeve sections together at 7 cm intervals as illustrated. Work 2 rows of crochet along neck edge. Using diagram as a guide cut out lace fabric section (add 1 cm seam allowance), and inset at front. Attach ribbon to neckline. Using crochet make loop at back neck opening, use bead as button. Attach beads around neck edge as illustrated. Embroider motif to compliment lace fabric. Insert shoulder pads.

SWEATER WITH NECK TRIM AND BOWS

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** SILVERKNIT Dakota: M—240 (250, 260, 270, 280) g (shade 6205). Shoulder pads, small pearl beads, 2 cm wide satin ribbon. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** St st: 40 sts = 12.1 cm and 60 rows = 12.5 cm (approx T3). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T0/0. Slide lever II.

BACK/FRONT

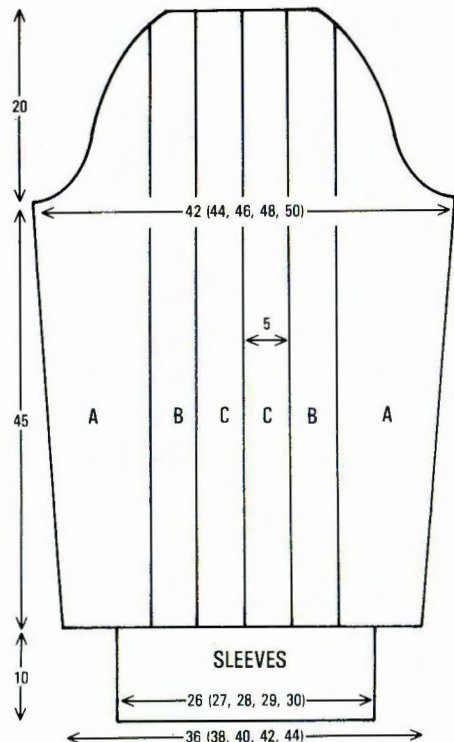
Work as SWEATER WITH LACE INSET FRONT.

SLEEVES

Using WY cast on 118 (126, 132, 138, 146) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR, 000. Change to M, T3. Working a 2 × 2 cable over centre 4 sts every 6 rows throughout, knit 20 rows. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 20th row × 10. 138 (146, 152, 158, 166) sts. **AT THE SAME TIME** at RC72 work a vertical row of holes each side of centre: **transfer st 16 to N 15 and st 17 to N 18, leave empty Ns in WP, knit 1 row. Release yarn caught on the 2 Ns and arrange in 'e' wrap. Knit 5 rows. ** Rep from ** to ** throughout. Knit to RC216, 000.

Sleeve head shaping

Cast off 5 (6, 7, 8, 9) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 2 (4, 6, 8, 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows,



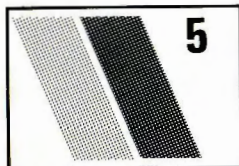
2 sts at beg of next 2 rows, 1 st at beg of next 8 rows, **1 st at beg of next 2 rows, knit 2 rows**. Rep from ** to ** × 12, 1 st at beg of next 24 rows. Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 8 rows, knit 2 rows. Cast off rem 48 (50, 50, 50, 52) sts.

Cuffs

Work as SWEATER WITH LACE INSET.

MAKE-UP

Block and press lightly all pieces. Join shoulder and side seams. Set in sleeves, gathering sleeve head to fit. Thread ribbon through holes on sleeves, as illustrated, and secure. **Neck trim:** Using M, COBH 13 sts, 000. T4 **knit 10 rows, trans centre st to adjacent N, leaving empty N in WP. ** Rep from ** to ** until long enough to fit along neck edge, cast off. Press lightly. Thread the cast-on edge through the first hole from wrong side to right side and pull through. Repeat along the work. Starting at centre back, attach trim to neck edge. **Bows:** Cast on 16 sts as FNR (count sts on MB only), 000. T3/3, work in circular knitting to RC192 and cast off. Press. Join to form a circle. Make a short cord and use to pull up bow at centre and attach to garment. Decorate with pearls as illustrated. Attach bows and insert shoulder pads.



DRESS

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** SILVERKNIT Oxtan: M—700 (710, 720, 730, 740) g (shade 3315). 15 × 1.5 cm buttons. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Tuck st (double length): 40 sts = 15.7 cm and 60 rows = 10.2 cm (approx T4 2/3), st st: 40 sts = 12.1 cm and 60 rows = 14.3 cm (approx T4).

NOTES: Cable insets—when casting on, count Ns on MB only.

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using WY cast on 126 (132, 138, 144, 150) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR. ** *Change to M, T4 knit 6 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T4 knit 6 rows*. Pick up first row knitted in M and place onto Ns, COL. Set carr to KC and knit 1 row, 000. T4 2/3 set card to double length and work in tuck throughout. Knit to RC436. ** Using WY mark each end of work, 000. Knit to RC220. Waste knit centre 74 sts for back neck, waste knit rem sts each side for shoulders.

Neckband

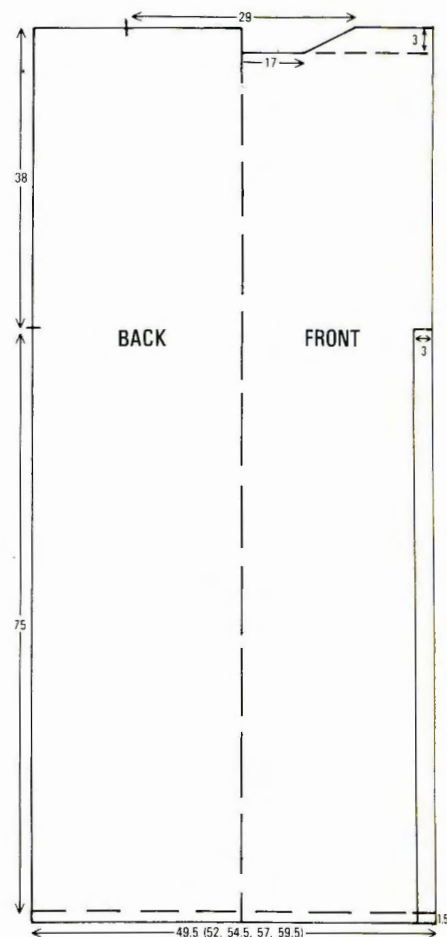

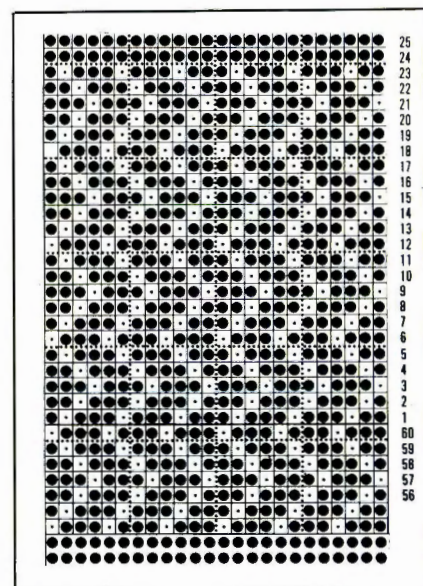

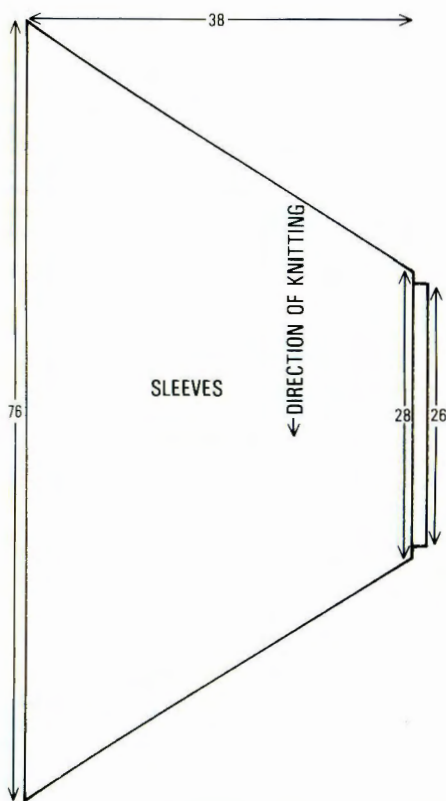

Waste knit centre 42 sts. Waste knit sts at right. COL, knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows, cast off 2 sts × 8, knit to RC220 and waste knit. Push 54 (58, 62, 66, 70) Ns into WP. Replace the sts at right onto Ns, inc evenly along the row, 000. COR, T4, working in st st knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 4 sts × 5, **AT THE SAME TIME** at RC6, make 3 buttonholes





over 3 sts evenly spaced along the row. Knit to RC12, T10 knit 1 row, 000. T4 knit 2 rows. At beg of next and alt rows, cast on 4 sts x 5. AT THE SAME TIME at RC6, work 3 buttonholes as before. Knit to RC12 and waste knit.

Neckband

With right side facing pick up 102 sts evenly along neck edge. Rep from * to *, waste knit.

SIDE SEAM BUTTON STRIP (BACK)

With right side facing, pick up 200 sts evenly from hem to marker. Using M, T4 knit 12 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T4 knit 12 rows, waste knit.

SIDE SEAM BUTTONHOLE STRIP (FRONT)

With right side facing, pick up 200 sts evenly from hem to cast-on sts. Using M, T4 knit 6 rows. Make 12 buttonholes over 3 sts evenly spaced along the row. Knit 6 rows. T10 knit 1 row, T4 knit 6 rows, work 12 buttonholes as before. Knit 6 rows, waste knit.

SLEEVE

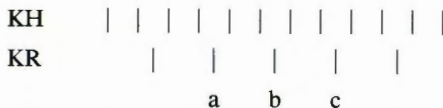
Lock card on row 1. Using WY cast on 96 sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. Change to M, T4 2/3. Set carr to KC, knit 1 row, 000. Set card to double length and work in tuck throughout. Set carr to H. Leaving 2 Ns in WP at right, push all rem Ns to HP. Knit 2 rows (take yarn round inside Ns to prevent hole). On next and alt rows take back to WP *** 1 st x 2, 2sts x 1 ***. Rep from *** to *** until all Ns are in WP. Knit to RC302, COR. At left bring forward to HP on next and alt rows **** 2 sts x 1, 1 st x 2****. Rep from **** to **** until all Ns are in HP. Change to st st and knit 1 row over all Ns, waste knit.

Cuffs

With right side facing, pick up 86 sts evenly along cuff edge. T4 knit 6 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T4 knit 6 rows. Waste knit.

CABLE INSETS

Using M cast on 12 sts as FNR. Arrange as follows:



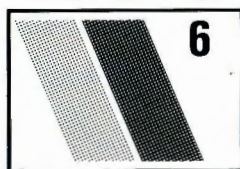

SCARF (to be attached to shoulder)

Using M, COBH 190 sts, 000. T4 knit 600 rows and waste knit. Block and press. Using WY cast on 34 (38, 42, 46, 50) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR. Change to M. *T4 knit 6 rows. Make 3 buttonholes over 3 sts evenly spaced along the row, knit 6 rows*. T10 knit 1 row. Rep from * to *. Pick up first row knitted in M and place onto Ns. Knit 1 row. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from last row knitted in M and place sts onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Block and lightly press all pieces. Join right shoulder by placing both sets of shoulder sts, with right sides facing, back onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Join neckband seam. Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Fold button band at shoulder in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Work rem buttonhole band on shoulder, and button band and buttonhole band at side seam to match. Press lightly. Attach buttons. Attach cable inset to top of sleeves and armhole edge. Join side seams. Graft sleeve seams. Join cuffs. Fold cuffs to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Work 2 rows of crochet along cast-on edge of scarf. Give final press. Finish buttonholes.



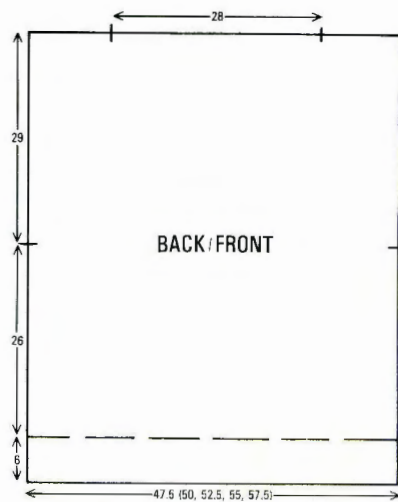
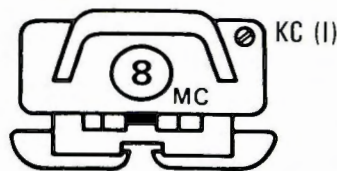
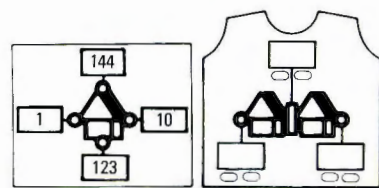

Using M cast on 143 (151, 157, 165, 173) sts as rib and knit 30 rows, 000. Trans to KH, T8, and knit to RC96. Using WY place a marker at each end of work. Knit to RC169. *Change to Con Col, knit 2 rows. Change to M, knit 2 rows. Set for fairisle and with M in FA and Con Col in FB work border patt as illustrated (21 rows). Using M only knit 2 rows. Change to Con Col only, knit 2 rows. * Change to M and knit to RC198. T7 knit 6 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T6 knit 6 rows.

BACK/FRONT

Using M, COBH 145 (153, 159, 167, 175) sts and rib 60 rows, 000. Change to card illustrated. T6, working in stripe patt throughout (see NOTES), knit to RC88. Using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC124. Waste knit centre 89 sts for neck opening. Waste knit rem 28 (32, 35, 39, 43) sts each side for shoulders.

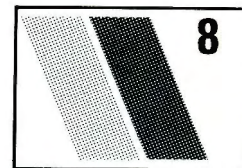
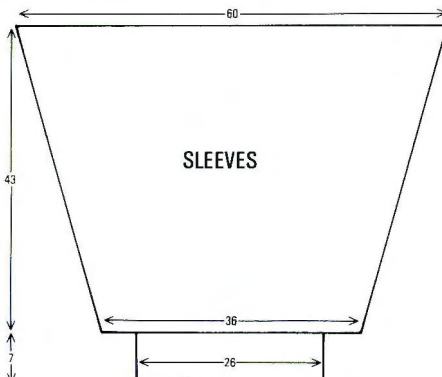


SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. With wrong side facing pick up 177 sts evenly along armhole edge between markers. Using K-carr and M, T6 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in KG-88 patt to RC3, dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 5th row $\times 35$. Knit to RC180 and waste knit. **Cuffs:** Push 77 Ns into WP. Pick up sts from cuff edge and place onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. Using M and K-carr, T6 knit 1 row, 000. Change to KG-88 and knit 36 rows in rib.

MAKE-UP

Block and press. Join side and sleeve seams. Using M, COBH 121 sts. Working in rib, T4 *knit 2 rows. Reduce T by $\frac{1}{3}$. * Rep from * to * throughout and AT THE SAME TIME, on RC3, dec 1 st at each end of next and every row until 89 sts rem. With right side facing, pick up 89 sts evenly along BACK neck and place onto Ns. Using K-carr, T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Work FRONT to match. Join neckband seam, fold to outside and stitch into position.



TUCK/WOVEN JACKET

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR and KL. **MATERIALS:** PHILDAR Anouchka: M—450 (475, 500, 525, 550) g (Noir 64). TWILLEY'S Goldfingering: A—175 (200, 225, 250, 275) g (Black WG31). Weaving yarns—approx 50 g each of 4 heavyweight yarns. Snap fasteners. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Tuck st: 40 sts = 15.4 cm and 60 rows = 12 cm (approx T8). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T1/1.

NOTES: Tuck patt — *Using M knit 4 rows. Using A knit 1 row.* Rep from * to * throughout. It is advisable to use 2 balls of M at the same time.

BACK AND LEFT FRONT

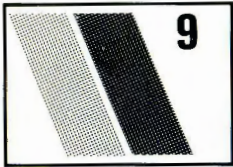
Work tuck st tension swatch using Card A (see NOTES) and set KL accordingly. Draw BACK and LEFT FRONT onto KL sheet. Beg and end work with WY. Work in tuck patt throughout.

RIGHT FRONT

Work weaving st tension swatch using Card B. Draw RIGHT FRONT onto KL sheet. Work in tuck patt to line A on diagram. Change KL setting to weaving tension and work to point B. Following squares indicated—weave in different colours as illustrated—work to point B. As the scale shows, push Ns that cross the diagonal line into HP. When all Ns are in HP return them all to WP and work second diagonal line. Work in the same manner throughout.

MAKE-UP

Join shoulder/upper arm seams. **Cuffs:** Using M cast on 107 sts as rib and knit 96 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, replace sts from base of sleeve back onto Ns, T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Back waist rib:** Using M cast on 139 (147, 155, 163, 169) sts as rib and knit 36 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts from back waist edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Left front waist:** Using M cast on 145 (153, 161, 169, 175) sts as rib and knit 36 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing pick up 139 (147, 155, 163, 169) sts from left front waist edge and place onto Ns leaving 6 sts at left edge. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Join side and sleeve seams. **Neckband:** Using M cast on 135 sts as rib and knit 16 rows. Change to circular knitting T7/7 and knit 8 circular rows. Waste knit. Attach neckband to neck edge—beg at centre front of left front and finishing at centre front of right front—by backstitching through last row knitted in M, first on the outside and then on the inside. **Trim:** Using M cast on 7 sts and knit a strip approx 5 metres. Attach to outside edge of right front and along cast-off edge of left front as illustrated. Work chain st to decorate edge of woven squares as illustrated. Attach snap fasteners at left shoulder, along left front opening and ribbing at waist.



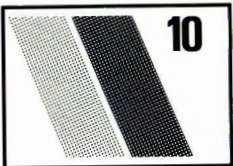

MACHINES: A or C with KR and KL and intarsia carriage. **MATERIALS:** LAINES ANNY BLATT No. 4 d'Anny Blatt: A—280 g (Brown 1879). LAINES ANNY BLATT Angor'Anny: B—80 g (Black 636), C—50 g (Brown 1233), D—45 g (White 625). PINGOUIN Viscosa: E—50 g (Brown 04). TWILLEY'S Gold Dust: F—50 g (Shade GD9), use 2 ends together. **MEASUREMENTS:** One size fits up to 106 cm bust (for larger sizes add to central section A on diagram). **TENSION:** St st: 40 sts = 15.2 cm and 60 rows = 16.7 cm (using A, B or C) (approx T9). **RIB:** 1×1 T4/4.

NOTES: Using 2 KL sheets draw out half diagram on each. Begin and end FRONT/BACK with waste knitting.

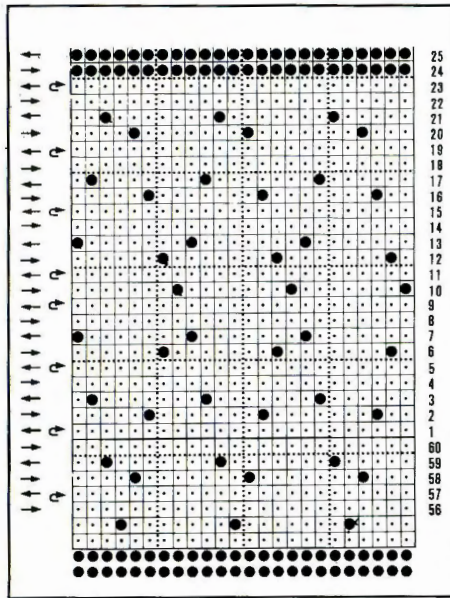
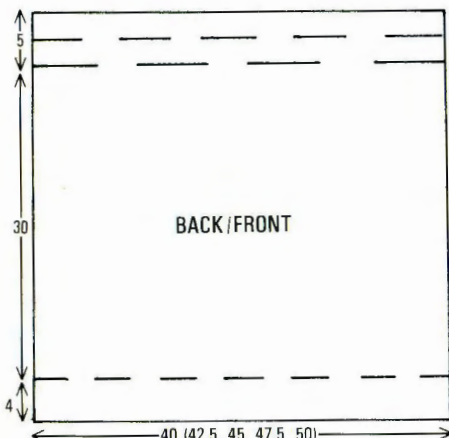

CAMISOLE

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** SILVERKNIT Pearl 4 ply: M—90 (100, 110, 120, 130) g (Pink 1225). Beads to decorate, elastic. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Lace: 40 sts = 14.8 cm and 60 rows = 18.2 cm (approx T5). **RIB:** 1×1 T0/0.



Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 109 (115, 121, 129, 135) sts as rib and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T5 release card and work in lace to RC98, 000. Trans to rib, knit 24 rows and cast off loosely.

MAKE-UP

Block and press excluding ribs. Make 2 cords—using M and circular knitting method—over 3 sts on each bed. Join side seams. Fold rib in half at neck edge and slipstitch into place encasing elastic. Attach cords to fit. Decorate with beads.

SKIRT

MACHINES: A, B or C. **MATERIALS:** Small amounts in each of: M—invisible thread; A—SILVERKNIT Pearl 4 ply (Pink 1225); B—SILVERKNIT Coton 4 ply (White 101). Lining fabric, interfacing, hooks and eyes, curtain weights, marabou to trim hem.

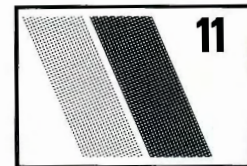
OVERSKIRT FABRIC

Using M, COBH required number of sts. T8 knit 1 row, 000.* **T5 using M knit 8 rows. T8 using M and A together knit 1 row.* Rep from * to * 3 times in all. Using M only knit 8 rows. Using M and B together, T9 knit 1 row. Using M only knit 2 rows. Using M and B together knit 1 row.** Rep from ** to ** throughout. Complete using 4 rows M and A together, T10 knit 1 row and cast off loosely.

SKIRT MAKE-UP

1. Measure waist and hips and decide on skirt length.
2. Make a tension square of overskirt knitted fabric.
3. To calculate amount of fabric: width will be 3× hip measurement, waistband width will be waist measurement + 5 cm + seam allowance. Waistband depth will be 10 cm + seam allowance.
4. Calculate the size and number of panels to be knitted to cover lining fabric.
5. Knit the panels and block and press.
6. Join lining fabric leaving centre back seam open, press seams.
7. Lay overskirt panels onto lining fabric and run a gathering thread through the waist edge of both.

8. Cut out waistband and cover wrong side with interfacing. With right sides together, fold waistband in half lengthwise and press. Fold back seam allowance and press into place.
9. Open out waistband and tack the skirt onto the pressed seam, allowing 5 cm for waistband wrapover. Attach skirt to waistband securely. Turn seam allowance into waistband and tack into position. Slipstitch and remove tacking thread.
10. Join centre back seam. Attach hooks and eyes. Attach marabou and curtain weights as needed. Turn up skirt lining to match overskirt.

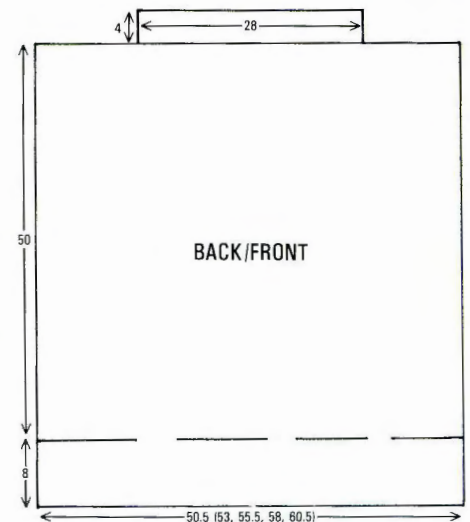

ATKINSON Cannele Cotton: B—190 (200, 210, 220, 230) g (Hirondelle 8031). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Using 2 ends of M in st st: 40 sts = 13.8 cm and 60 rows = 15.3 cm (approx T8). Using 1 end of A and st st: 40 sts = 13.2 cm and 60 rows = 15.3 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** 4×4 T5/5—cable every 6 rows on KH only.

BACK/FRONT

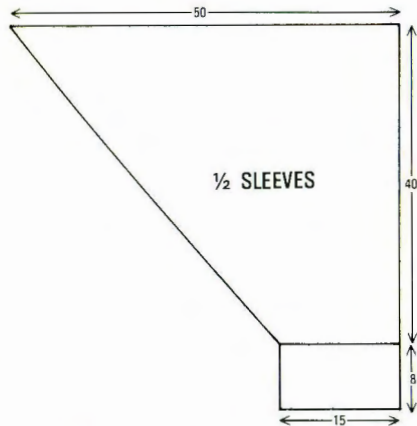
Using WY cast on 146 (154, 162, 168, 176) sts and knit a few rows, 000. T8 change to M and knit to RC196. Waste knit 32 (36, 40, 43, 47) sts at each end for shoulders. Place sts from first row knitted in M onto Ns, distributing them evenly along the row. Trans to rib (see RIB), knit 30 rows and cast off.

Using B, COBH 152 sts, 000. T5 knit to RC18. With wrong side facing, pick up sts

from one side of BACK/Front and place onto Ns—neck edge to right, 000. Change to A, T6, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and every foll alt row dec 2 sts × 28, then 1 st × 50. Knit to RC156 and waste knit. Rep once more, reversing shapings. Knit second sleeve to match. Cuffs: Push 74 Ns into WP. Replace sts from both cuff edges onto Ns, distributing them evenly along the row. Using B, T5 knit 1 row, 000. Trans to rib (see RIB) and knit to RC30. Cast off.



MAKE-UP

Join sleeve and neckband seams.

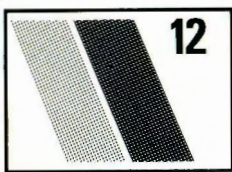

Trans to 3 × 3 rib. Pitch Lever to H, 000. T6/6 knit 30 rows. *Reduce tension by 1/3 and knit 30 rows.* Rep from * to * to RC210. Trans to 1 × 1 rib. T2/2 knit 25 rows. T1/1 knit 25 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T4 knit 12 rows. T10 knit 1 row. T4 knit 12 rows, cast off loosely.

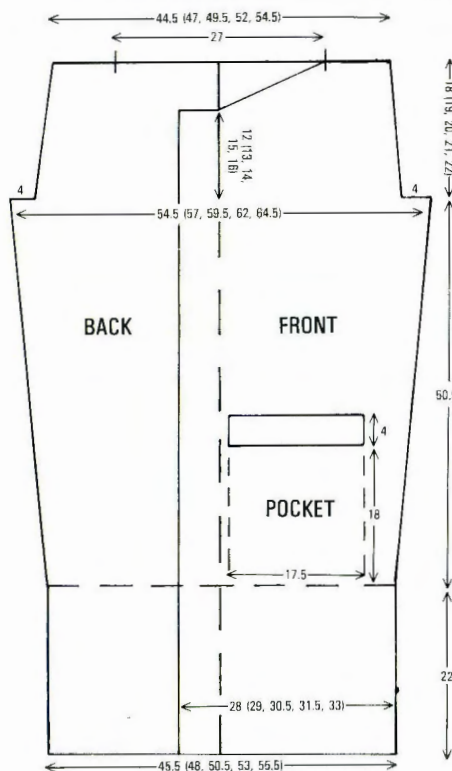
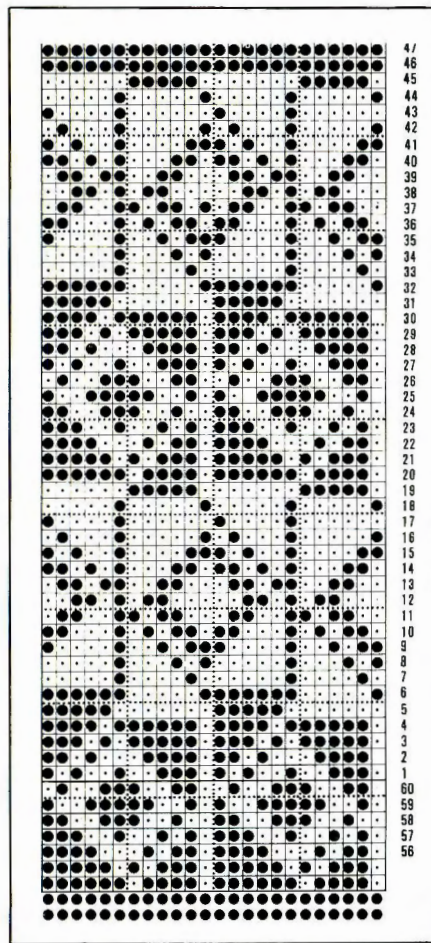

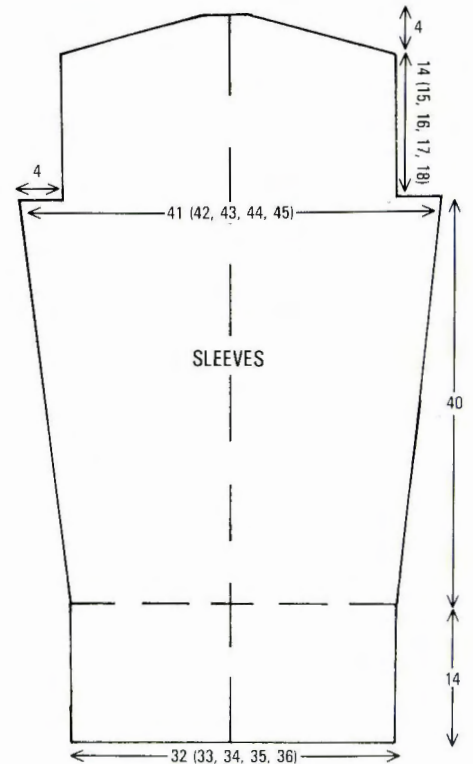

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 123 (129, 137, 143, 151) sts as rib and knit 86 rows. Trans to KH. T10 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in fairisle to RC2. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 15th row × 12—147 (153, 161, 167, 175) sts. Knit to RC182. 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 11 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to

RC16 (17, 18, 19, 20). Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 16 (17, 18, 19, 20)th row 3 times in all. Knit to RC64 (68, 72, 76, 80). Waste knit centre 73 sts. Waste knit rem 23 (26, 30, 33, 37) sts each side for shoulders.



Pockets

Using M, COBH 48 sts, 000. T9 knit to RC65 and waste knit.

RIGHT FRONT

Lock card on row 1. Using M cast on 77 (79, 83, 85, 89) sts as rib and knit 86 rows. COL, trans to KH, T10 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in fairisle to RC2. Inc 1 st at right on next and every foll 15th row × 12. AT THE SAME TIME at RC65...

Place pocket

Waste knit 48 sts—4 patt repeats—approx central, as illustrated. Replace sts from pocket bag back onto Ns and work to RC182. 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 11 sts at beg of next row. Knit to RC16 (17, 18, 19, 20). Dec 1 st at right on next and every foll 16 (17, 18, 19, 20)th row, 3 times in all. AT THE SAME TIME at RC42 (46, 50, 54, 58)...

Shape front neck

COR, at left on next and every foll alt row push 15 (14, 14, 13, 13) Ns × 1, 10 Ns × 1, 8 Ns × 1, 6 Ns × 1, 2 Ns × 3, 1 N × 1 to HP. Knit to RC64 (68, 72, 76, 80) and waste knit over the 23 (26, 30, 33, 37) Ns in WP. Return Ns at left to WP and waste knit.

LEFT FRONT

As RIGHT FRONT reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Set card on row 14. Using M cast on 87 (89, 91, 95, 97) sts as rib and knit 56 rows. Trans to KH, T10 knit 1 row, 000. Release card

and work in fairisle to RC2. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 12th row \times 12—111 (113, 115, 119, 121) sts. Knit to RC144. 000.

Sleeve head shaping

Cast off 11 sts at beg of next 2 rows—89 (91, 93, 97, 99) sts. Knit to RC50 (54, 58, 62, 66). At beg of next and every foll row cast off 6 sts \times 14. Cast off rem 5 (7, 9, 13, 15) sts.

FRONT FACINGS (2)

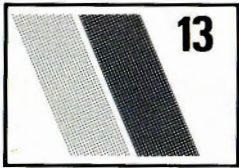

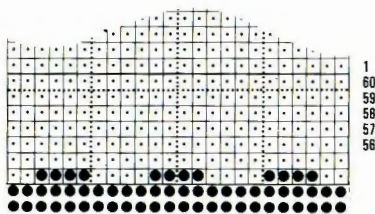

NOTES: Lock card on row 1 throughout. With M in FA and Con Col in FB, *knit 6 rows, cable 2 over 2 every alt set of 4 Ns in UWP, knit 6 rows, cable 2 over 2 on rem groups of 4 Ns in UWP*. Rep from * to * throughout. Use 2 ends of M together throughout.

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using WY cast on 78 (82, 86, 90, 94) sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. Using M, T5 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in fairisle to RC6. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6 (6, 7, 7, 7)th row×7—90 (94, 100, 104, 108) sts. Knit to RC54, 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC56. Waste knit centre 30 sts. Waste knit 26 (28, 31, 33, 35) sts each side for shoulders.

LEFT FRONT

Lock card on row 1. Using WY cast on 38 (40, 42, 44, 46) sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. Using M, T5 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in fairisle to RC7. Inc 1 st at left on next and every foll 7 (7, 6, 6, 6)th row×6 (6, 7, 7, 7) and, AT THE SAME TIME, at RC14...

Shape neckline

Dec 1 st at right on next and every foll 7th row×14. AT THE SAME TIME at RC53, COL, 000...

Armhole shaping

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row. Knit to RC63 and waste knit.

RIGHT FRONT

As LEFT FRONT reversing shapings.

T0 knit the required number of rows and then latch up the horizontal loops to form a 1×1 rib.

T1 change to C and knit 3 rows. Pick up the first horizontal loop left by the N in NWP and place on adjacent N in WP. Push all Ns into WP. Knit required number of rows. Drop the sts on every 3rd N. Using the latchet tool pick up the first horizontal loop and keep on latchet tool behind latched. Make a stitch with the 4th horizontal loop, then latch up to the top of work, placing last st back onto N. With rib completed, waste knit, turn work and replace onto Ns. **NOTES:** Stripe patt sequence—with M in FA and working in weaving patt as follows: *4 rows A, 4 rows B, 4 rows A, 1 row C, 2 rows A, 1 row C.* Rep from * to * throughout.

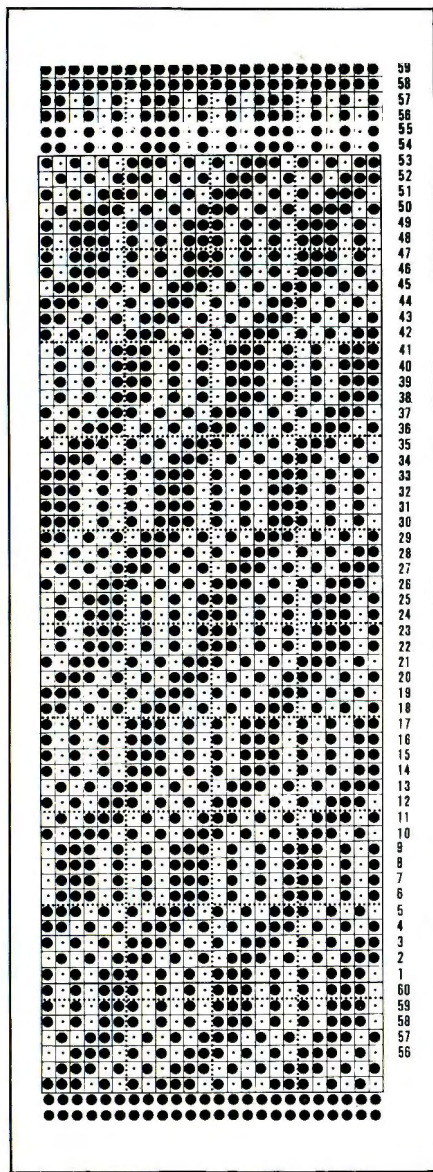

Neck shaping

At beg of next and alt rows, cast off 3 sts $\times 1$, 2 sts $\times 3$, 1st $\times 4$, knit to RC96 and cast off rem 2 sts.

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using WY cast on 51 sts and knit a few rows, COR. T3 using M, set carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns, 000. 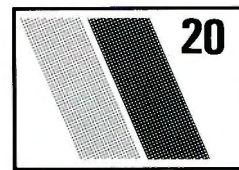
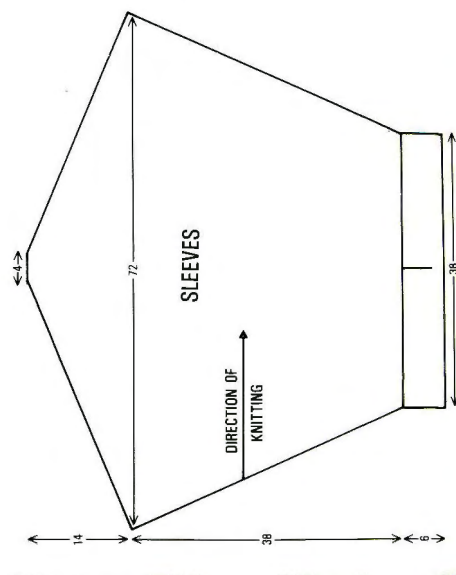

Armhole shaping

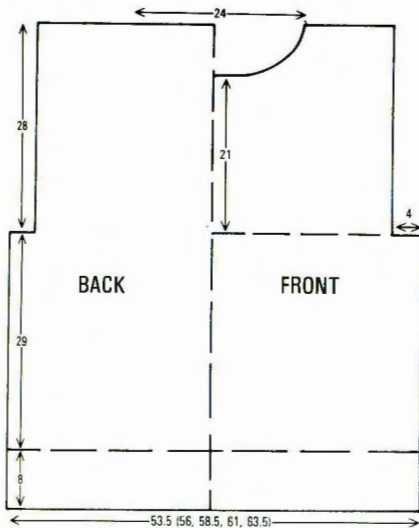

NOTES: Set card for double length. *Tuck/skip/stripe patt:* *Depress both TUCK buttons. Using M knit 4 rows. Change to A, knit 6 rows. Change to M, knit 2 rows. Depress both PART buttons. Change to B, knit 4 rows. Change to A, knit 2 rows.* Repeat from * to * throughout.

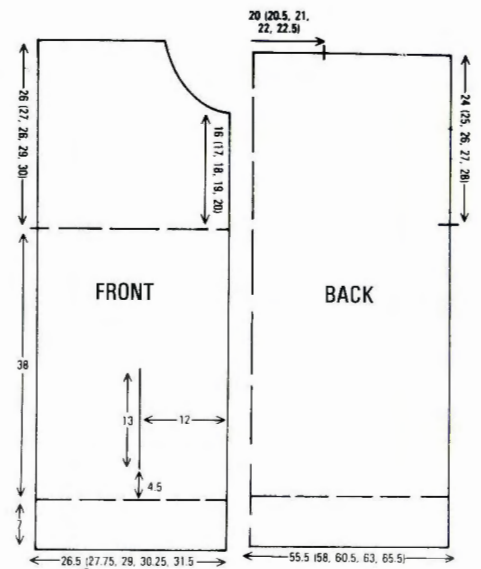

Cable trim: 10 sts = 4 cm and 30 rows = 14 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** Cast on with every 3rd N in NWP then latch up horizontal loops to form a rib. Count Ns in NWP as sts when knitting ribs.

COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 2 sts \times 1, then dec 1 st \times 3—15 (17, 18, 20, 21, 23) sts rem. Knit to RC70 (70, 78, 80, 92, 100) and waste knit. Return left side to Ns, reset card and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

CABLE INSERT

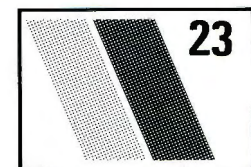

Push 31 (31, 34, 37, 40, 43) Ns into WP. Place sts from cuff edge onto Ns, distributing them evenly along the row. Using M, T6 knit 1 row, 000. Trans every 3rd st to its adjacent N. Knit 20 rows. Latch up horizontal loops to form a rib and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join cable insert to 3 shoulder seams. Push 68 (68, 72, 74, 78, 78) Ns into WP. DO NOT REMOVE WY. With right side facing, place sts along neck edge onto Ns. T6 knit 1 row. Trans every 3rd st to adjacent N. Knit 20 rows. Latch up horizontal loops to form a rib. Knit 1 row and waste knit. Join rem shoulder seam and neckband seam. Turn neckband to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Remove all WY. Set in sleeves and join side and underarm seams.



JUMPSUIT

MACHINES: A or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** KING COLE Superspun Superwash 4 ply: M—300 (320, 340, 360) g (French Navy 25), A—110 (120, 140, 160) g (Bluebell 26), B—Small amount (Amber 10), 6 snap fasteners, ribbon for facing. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 80 (90, 100, 110) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle: 40 sts = 12.7 cm and 60 rows = 16.4 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T1/1. Sweater illustrated as patt 25.

NOTES: Colour sequence Card A— with M in FA and A in FB knit 5 rows. *With M in FA and B in FB knit 2 rows. With M in FA and A in FB knit 13 rows.* Rep from * to *. Card B— M in FA and A in FB.

RIGHT BACK LEG

Insert card A and lock on row 1. Using WY

cast on 49 (52, 55, 58) sts—1 st to right of '0' and rem sts to left of '0'—knit a few rows ending with COL. Change to M. Set carr to KC, knit 1 row, 000. Set for fairisle as given in NOTES to RC37. Change to Card B (see NOTES) and lock on row 1. Knit 1 row, release card, knit to RC88 (106, 120, 138) and waste knit.

LEFT BACK LEG

As RIGHT BACK LEG except: cast on 1 st to left of '0' and rem sts to right of '0' and DO NOT WASTE KNIT. COR, dec 1 st at left. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from RIGHT BACK LEG and place onto Ns at left of '0', dec 1 st at right—96 (102, 108, 114) sts. Lock card. Release yarn from feeders. Set carr to N and depress both PART buttons. Take carr to left. Set carr to KC, take carr to right (Ns are selected ready to cont in fairisle patt). Set for fairisle, release card, replace yarn into feeders, 000.*** Work in fairisle to RC88 (96, 102, 110), 000. Using WY place a marker at each end of work. Knit 9 rows. Change to Card A and work in fairisle patt as given in NOTES to RC48 (52, 56, 58). Waste knit 29 (32, 35, 38) sts at each end for shoulders. Waste knit rem 38 sts for back neck.

FRONT

As BACK to ***. Cont in fairisle to RC26 (26, 30, 30).

Divide for FRONT opening

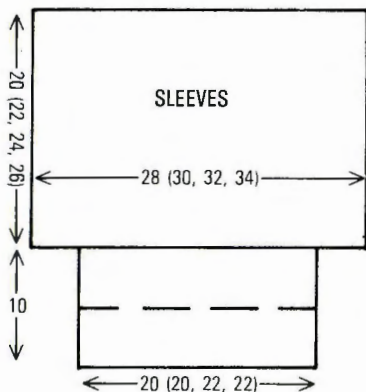

Trans to rib, knit 2 rows, COR. ***On side opposite carr bring forward to HP 2 Ns, knit 1 row.*** Rep from *** to *** \times 6. ****On side opposite carr take back to WP 2 inside Ns, knit 1 row.*** Rep from **** to **** until all Ns are in WP, knit 2 rows over all Ns. Trans to KH, T6 knit 2 rows and waste knit. Fold to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M.

NOTES: Fairisle patt — with M in FA throughout, knit 20 rows with A in FB, *2 rows with B in FB, 28 rows with A in FB.* Rep from * to * throughout. For skirt illustrated, see patt 25.

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M, COBH 109 (115, 121, 127) sts. T5 knit 13 rows. T10 knit 1 row, 000. T6 release card and work in fairisle patt (see NOTES) to RC74 (80, 94, 110), 000.

Raglan shaping

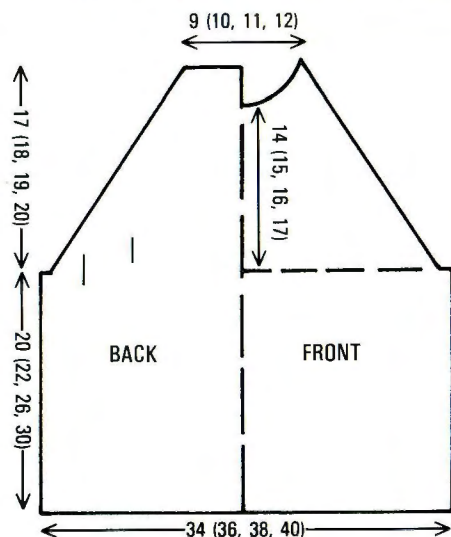

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 112 (117, 124, 131) sts as rib and knit 30



rows. Trans to KH, 000. T6 release card and work in fairisle to RC92 (106, 116, 124). Using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000.* Knit to RC52 (56, 58, 62). Waste knit 36 (38, 41, 44) sts at each end for shoulders. Cast off rem 40 (41, 42, 43) sts.

FRONT

As BACK to *. Knit to RC18 (22, 26, 30).

Neck shaping

Cast off centre 12 (13, 12, 13) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at beg of next and foll alt rows $\times 8$, then every 3rd row $\times 6$ (6, 7, 7). Knit to RC58 (62, 66, 70), waste knit rem 36 (38, 41, 48) sts. Knit second side to match, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

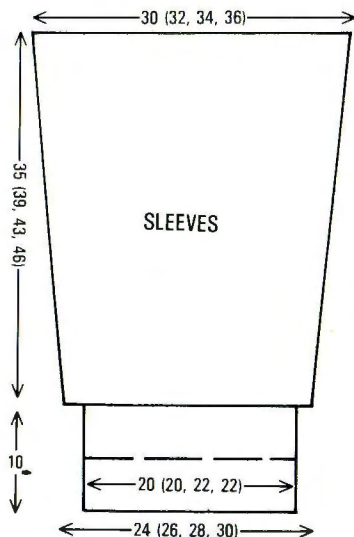
Lock card on row 1. Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. With wrong side facing, pick up 93 (99, 105, 111) sts evenly along armhole edge between markers, 000. T6 release card and work in fairisle to RC10 (10, 14, 14). Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 11 (13, 14 15)th row $\times 9$. Knit to RC128 (142, 156, 166) and waste knit. Block and press. **Cuffs:** Push 63 (63, 69, 69) Ns into WP. With wrong side facing, place sts from cuff edge onto Ns, distributing them evenly along the row. Using M, T6 knit 1 row. Trans to rib, knit 52 rows and cast off loosely.

COLLAR

Using M cast on 27 sts as rib and knit 200 rows, waste knit. Begin at cast-on edge, attach collar to neck edge as illustrated, undo knitting to fit and cast off. Attach both ends of collar to centre front as illustrated. Give final press.

RIBBED SKIRT

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** KING COLE Superspun Superwash 4 ply: M—140 (160, 180, 200, 220, 240) g (colours illustrated—French Navy 25 and Wild Rose 118), small amounts in two contrast colours (colours illustrated—Bluebell 26, Wild Rose 118 and French Navy 25), elastic to fit waist + 2.5 cm. **MEASUREMENTS:** Height 100 (110, 120, 130, 140, 150) cm. Approx length 31 (35, 39, 43, 47, 51) cm.



SKIRT (2 pieces)

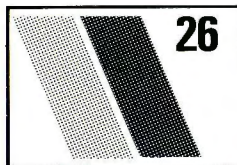
Using M, T1 cast on 182 sts as FNR—work 2 rows CIRCULAR KNITTING ONLY. COL, 000. T3/3 knit 1 row. Trans to 3 \times 3 rib, pitch H. Working in stripe patt of 6 rows M, 2 rows first Con Col, 6 rows M, 2 rows second Con Col, and starting with T6/6, knit to RC20. *Reduce tension by $\frac{1}{2}$, knit 20 rows*. Rep from * to * to RC92 (108, 116, 132, 148, 164), 000. Trans to 1 \times 1 rib, T3/3 knit 16 (16, 20, 20, 20, 20) rows. T2/2 knit 16 (16, 20, 20, 20, 20) rows. Trans to KH and waste knit.

Waistband

Press. Join one side seam. Using WY cast on 182 sts and knit a few rows, COL. Change to M, T5 knit 14 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T5 knit 14 rows. Turn up hem. T6 knit 1 row. Replace sts from waist edge of skirt back onto Ns placing 2 sts onto every N. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join rem seam and waistband seam, leaving an opening for elastic. Thread elastic through waistband and join securely, closed waistband seam and give final press.



TUCK-RIB SWEATERS & CARDIGANS

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** SUNBEAM Pacemaker 4 ply: *Round neck:* M—260 (280, 300, 325) g (Spice 2021). *V-neck:* M—250 (270, 290, 320) g (Pillar Box 2018). *Round neck cardigan:* M—300 (325, 360, 390) g (Aster 2009). *V-neck cardigan:* M—275 (300, 340, 375) g (Royal 2026). 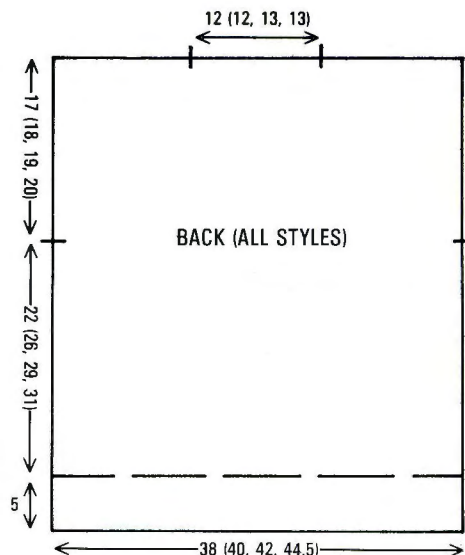

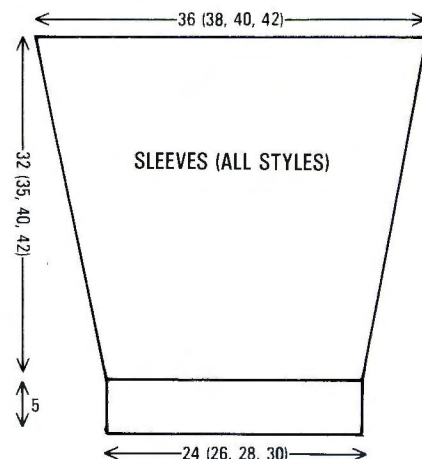

Dec 1 st at left on next and alt rows $\times 4$, then every 4th row $\times 4$, 24 (25, 26, 29) sts rem. ***Knit to RC108 (114, 120, 126). Pitch to P, trans all sts on KR to KH, set for st st, waste knit***. Knit second side to match, reversing shapings. Join one shoulder by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. Knit one loose row MANUALLY and cast off. **Neckband:** With right side facing, pick up 102 (102, 110, 110) sts evenly along neck edge. T8 knit 1 row. Trans to rib, knit 26 rows. Trans to KH, T8 knit 2 rows and waste knit.

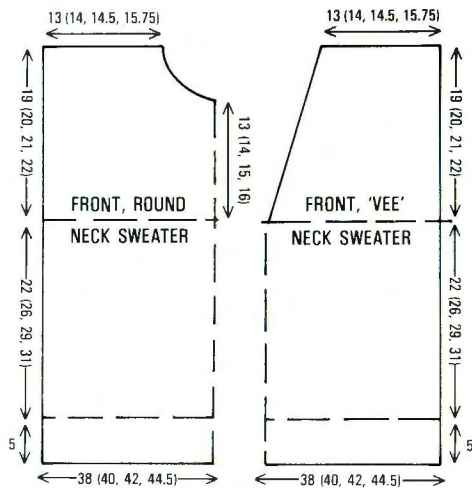

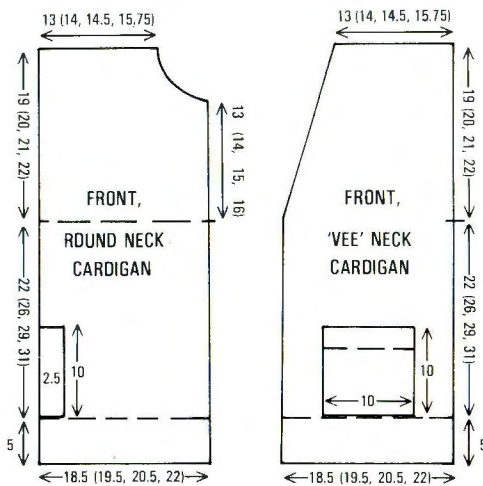

Pick up 36 (36, 38, 40) sts evenly along back neck, inc sts as necessary, and place onto Ns, rep from **** to ****. Pick up 61 (63, 66, 69) sts evenly along second side of V and place onto Ns. Rep from **** to ****.

MAKE-UP

Join side and sleeve seams, mitre neckband.



V-NECK CARDIGAN

Pockets

Lock card on row 1. Using M, COBH 18 sts. T8 knit 1 row. Trans sts as N arrangement making sts where necessary, 000. T8/2 release card and work in patt to RC44, waste knit.

FRONTS

Lock card on row 1. Using M cast on 34 (36, 37, 40) sts as rib, knit 21 rows, rep from * to * as BACK. Knit to RC44. Waste knit centre

18 sts. Replace sts from top of pocket onto Ns. Knit to RC126 (148, 166, 176). Using WY place a marker at left side of work, 000. Knit 4 (4, 4, 8) rows. At right dec 1 st on next and every foll 10th row \times 10 (11, 11, 11). Knit to RC108 (114, 120, 126) rep from *** to *** as ROUND NECK SWEATER. Knit second side to match reversing shapings.

MAKE-UP

Join side and sleeve seams. *Pocket tops:* Push 30 Ns into WP, with right side facing place sts from top of pocket onto Ns, inc where necessary. T7 knit 1 row. Trans to rib and knit 12 rows, cast off. Stitch pockets to inside and pocket top to main garment. *Button band:* Using M cast on 142 (158, 170, 178) sts as rib and knit 10 rows. Trans to KH. T7 knit 1 row. With wrong side facing, pick up sts along centre front from hem to shoulder, place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. *Buttonhole band:* As Button Band working 6 (6, 8, 8) \times 2-st buttonholes evenly on 5th row—allow 81 (93, 102, 108) sts for centre front edge. *Back neckband:* Using M cast on 38 sts and work as Button Band. Join neckband seams and attach buttons.

ROUND NECK CARDIGAN

Pockets

Lock card on row 1. Using M, COBH 18 sts, 000. T8 knit 1 row. Trans sts as N arrangement making sts where necessary, 000. T8/2 release card and work in patt to RC56, cast off.

FRONT

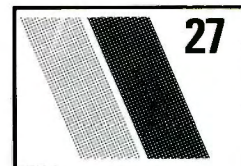

Neck shaping

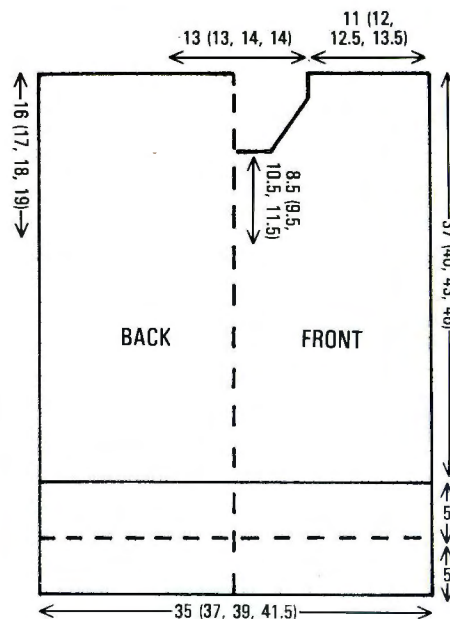
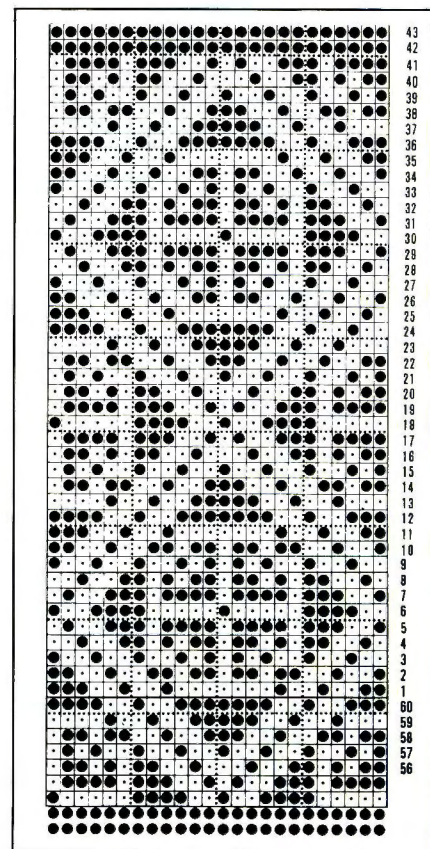

PHILDAR Baby Luxe 3 ply 022: As M—200 (200, 250, 250) g (White), as Con Col—150 (150, 200, 200) g. 2 buttons. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 120 (130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle: 40 sts = 11.8 cm and 60 rows = 14.3 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T3/3.



BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 119 (125, 133, 141) sts as rib and knit 48 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T6 release card and work in fairisle to RC 88. (96, 104, 112). Using WY place a marker at each end of work. Knit to RC156 (168, 180, 192). Using a separate length of M, cast off centre 45 (45, 47, 47) sts for back neck. Waste knit rem 37 (40, 43, 47) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

As BACK to RC124 (136, 148, 160).

Neck shaping

(NOTE CARD POSITION.) Using a separate length of M, cast off centre 9 (9, 11, 11) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 4 sts × 1, 3 sts × 1, 2 sts × 1, then dec 1 st × 9 — 37 (40, 43, 47) sts rem. Knit to RC156 (168, 180, 192) and waste knit. Reset card, replace sts from left back onto Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

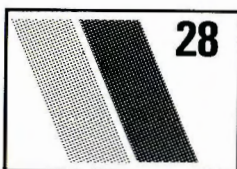
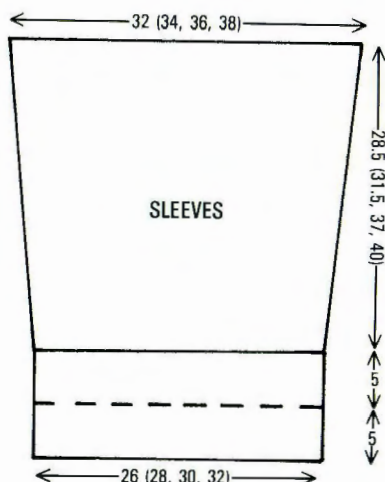

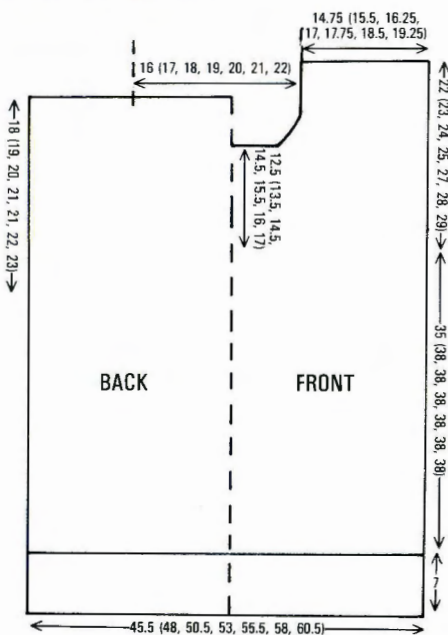

As BACK to RC44 (46, 50, 50, 54, 56, 60) above WY markers.



Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Waste knit centre 13 sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows, cast off 4 sts × 1, 3 sts × 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 2, 2), 2 sts × 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 1, 1), and 1 st × 8 (9, 10, 10, 11, 12, 13) — 42 (45, 48, 49, 52, 54, 56) sts rem. Knit to RC78 (80, 84, 88, 94, 98, 102) and waste knit. Reset card. Replace sts from left side back onto Ns and knit to match, reversing shapings.

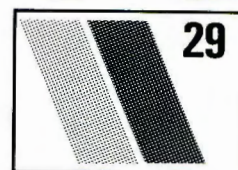
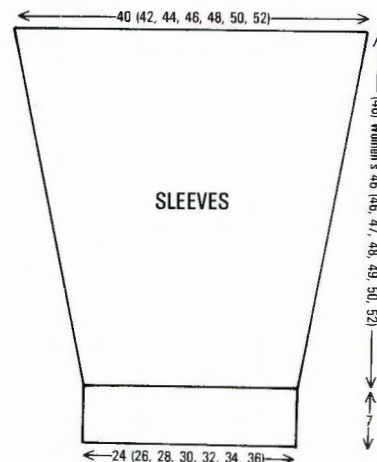

Change to M, T10/8, knit 1 row. T3/3 knit 16 rows. Trans all sts to KH, T7 knit 1 row. With wrong side facing pick up sts from around neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

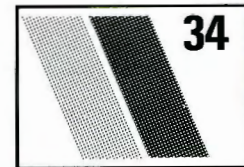
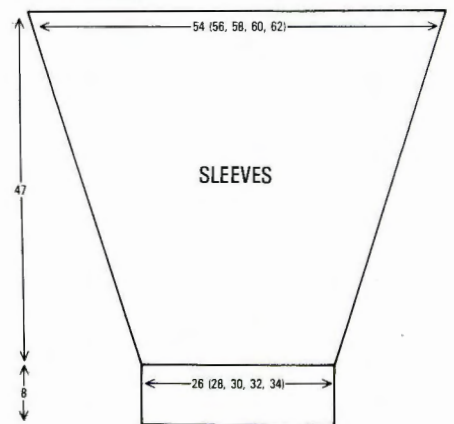
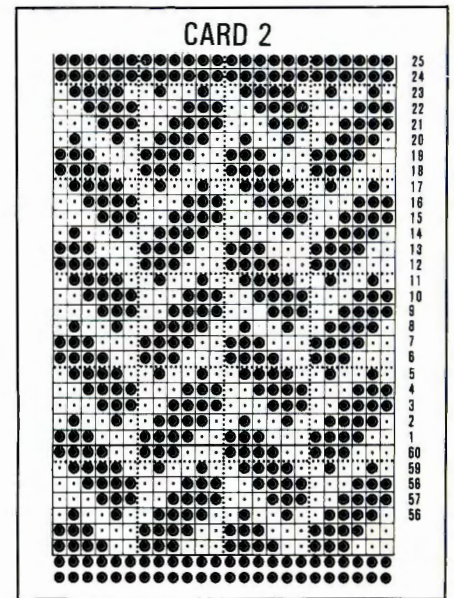

Insert Card 2 and lock on row 1. Join second shoulder as first. With wrong side facing, pick up 174 (180, 186, 192, 198) sts evenly along armhole edge between markers, 000. T7 with Con Col only knit to RC7. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 7th row x 23, AT THE SAME TIME at RC76, T8 release card and work in fairisle to RC106, then change to M only, knit 4 rows, change to Card 1 and with M in FA and Con Col in FB knit to RC178, 000. Change to Con Col and rib, knit 34 rows and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Block and press. Join neckband seam, fold along loose row and press lightly to outside. Join side and sleeve seams.

MACHINES: C with KR830. **MATERIALS:** SILVERKNIT Oxtom: M—420 (430, 440, 450, 460) g (Black 3328), Con Col—340 (350, 360, 370, 380) g (Blue 3383), small amount of leather. Snap fasteners. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Jacquard patt: 40 sts = 12.9 cm and 60 rows = 9.1 cm (approx T2/2). **RIB:** 1×1 T3/3 (2 ends together).

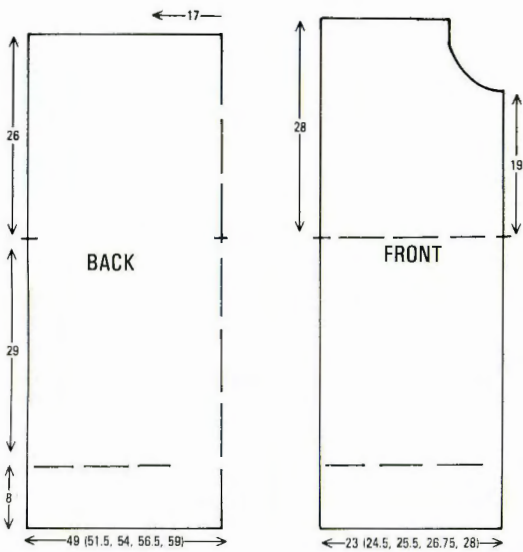
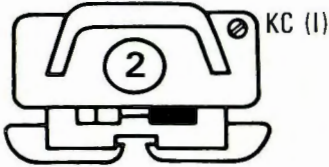
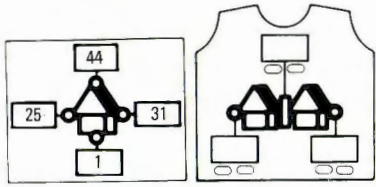
BACK

Using M cast on 151 (159, 167, 175, 183) sts as rib and knit 36 rows. Change to FNR and 1 end, knit 1 row, 000. T2/2 work in jacquard patt to RC192. Using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC172. Trans all sts to KH, T4 knit 1 row. Waste knit 49 (53, 57, 61, 65) sts at each end of work for shoulders. Cast off rem 53 sts.

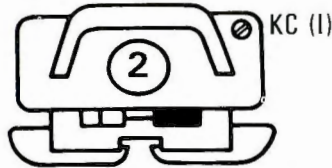
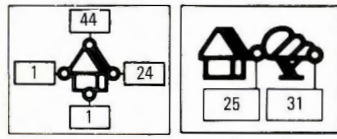

Waste knit, turn work and replace sts back onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up 167 sts evenly along armhole edge between markers and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

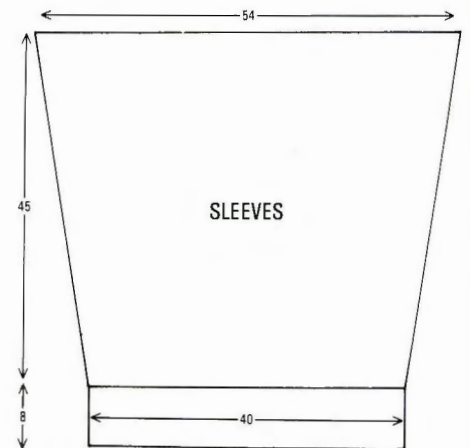
Join side and sleeve seams. *Collar:* Using 1 end of M cast on 130 sts as FNR. T2/2, 000. Knit to RC40. Change to circular knitting, 000. T3/3 knit to RC8 and waste knit. Attach collar to neck edge by backstitching through last row knitted in M, first on the

outside and then on the inside. Cut 2 strips of leather 5 cm wide x length of centre front opening, fold in half lengthways. Attach to front opening as illustrated, attach fasteners.

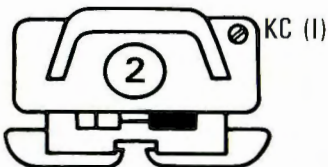
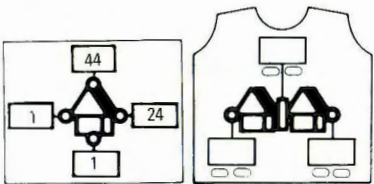

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** KING COLE Superspun Superwash 4 ply: M—630 (640, 650, 670, 680) g (Black 48), A—80 (90, 100, 110, 120) g (Scarlet 9). Small amount of grey leather, 9 fasteners. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit chest 91 (96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** English rib: 40 sts = 13.4 cm and 60 rows = 8.5 cm (approx T3/3). St st: 40 sts = 12.1 cm and 60 rows = 15.3 cm (approx T5). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T1/1.



BACK

Using M cast on 165 (173, 181, 187, 195) sts as rib and knit 36 rows. Change to English rib, 000. T3/3, knit to RC246, 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC8. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 8th row 15 times in all. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 13 (15, 17, 18, 20). Knit to RC176 (182, 190, 196, 204) and waste knit rem 45 sts.

LEFT FRONT

Using M cast on 61 (65, 67, 73, 75) sts as rib and knit 36 rows. Change to English rib, T3/3, 000. Knit to RC 247, 000.

Raglan shaping

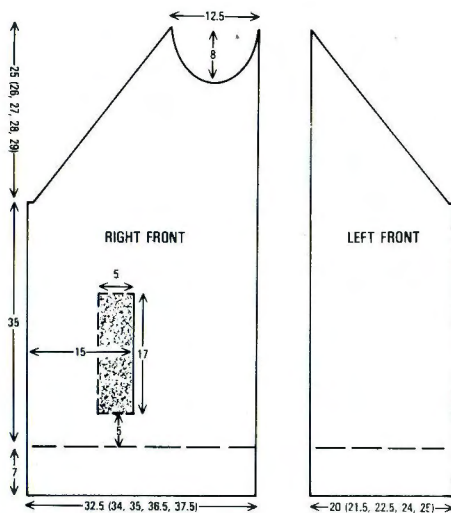
COL. Cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next row. Knit to RC7. At left dec 2 sts on next and every foll 8th row × 16 (16, 17, 15, 16) then every 4th row × 11 (13, 13, 18, 18). Knit to RC175 (181, 189, 195, 203). Fasten off.

RIGHT FRONT

Using M cast on 97 (103, 105, 109, 113) sts as rib and knit 36 rows. Change to English rib, 000. T3/3, knit 35 rows, COL.

Pocket opening

Waste knit 45 sts at right. Knit to RC156 and waste knit. Replace sts at right back onto Ns (set RC to 35), COL. Cast on 39 sts at beg of next row. Knit to RC155, COL. Cast off 39



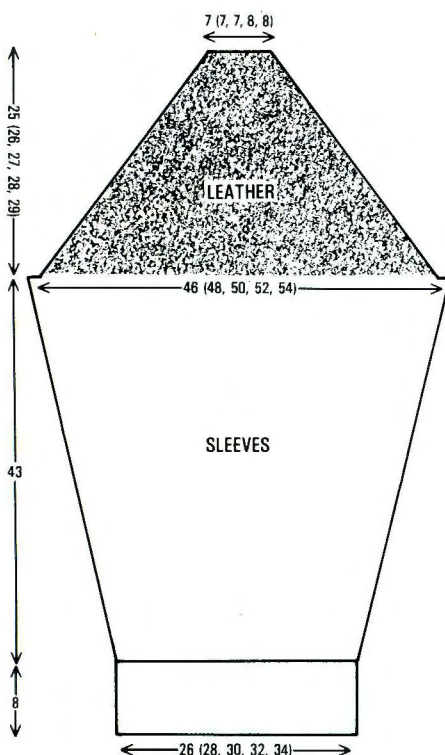
sts at beg of next row, knit 1 row. Replace sts from waste knitting back onto Ns and knit to RC246, 000.

Raglan shaping

COR, cast off 4 (4, 4, 5, 5) sts at beg of next row. Knit to RC8. At right edge dec 12 sts on next and every foll 8th row × 16 (16, 17, 15, 16) then every foll 4th row × 11 (13, 13, 18, 18). AT THE SAME TIME at RC 121 (127, 135, 141, 149)...

Shape neck

COL. Push 24 (26, 26, 24, 26) Ns at left into HP and waste knit sts at right. Return Ns to WP and knit 1 row, COR. Cast off 11 (13, 13, 11, 13) sts at beg of next row. Knit 3 rows. At neck edge on next and every foll 4th row dec 1 st × 10. Knit to RC176 (182, 190, 196, 204) and fasten off. Replace sts from second side back onto Ns. Cont raglan dec's and AT THE SAME TIME, after 4 rows, dec 1 st at neck edge on next and every foll 4th row × 10. Knit to RC176 (182, 190, 196, 204) and fasten off.



SLEEVES

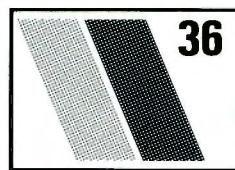
Using M cast on 85 (93, 99, 105, 113) sts as rib and knit 40 rows. Trans to KH, 000. Using A, T5 work in st st, knit to RC4. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 33, knit to RC168, and AT THE SAME TIME at RC86, working in intarsia, knit the centre st in M then inc by 1 st at each side every row until all sts are in M. 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 4 (4, 5, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit 2 rows. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 18 (18, 19, 19, 19), then every alt row × 12 (14, 14, 15, 17). Knit to RC98 (102, 106, 110, 114) and waste knit rem 23 (23, 23, 27, 27) sts.

MAKE-UP

Block and press sleeves lightly. Join raglan, side and sleeve seams. Sew in pockets. **Neckband:** Using M cast on 169 sts as rib and knit 14 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts from neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Button bands:** Using M cast on 15 sts as 1 × 1 rib and knit to required length. Attach bands to front opening. Attach leather to sleeve raglans, pocket edge and button bands as illustrated. Attach fasteners.



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MAN'S INTARSIA SWEATER

MACHINE: D with KR. **MATERIALS:** PINGOUIN Jarre: M—410 (430, 450, 470, 500) g (Noir 03). PINGOUIN Sportlaine: Con Col — 180 (190, 200, 210, 240) g (Bavière 510). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit chest 91 (96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** St st: 20 sts = 12.5 cm and 30 rows = 14 cm (using M only) (approx T6). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T0/0.

BACK

Using Con Col cast on 87 (91, 95, 99, 103) sts as rib and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH, 000. Using M, T6 *knit to RC82. Using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC52 (54, 56, 58, 60). Waste knit centre 33 sts. Waste knit 27 (29, 31, 33, 35) sts at each side for shoulders.

FRONT

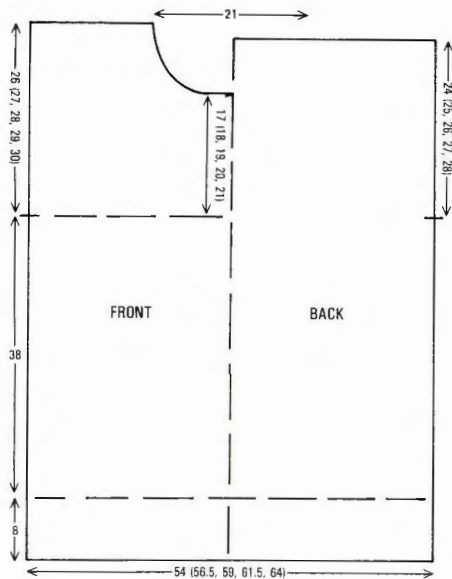
As BACK to *. Knit to RC20. Foll chart, work intarsia motif at centre and, AT THE SAME TIME, at RC82 using WY place a marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC36 (38, 40, 42, 44).

Neck shaping

Waste knit centre 13 sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR, knit 1 row. At beg of next and foll alt rows cast off 2 sts × 2, then dec 1 st × 6. Knit to RC56 (58, 60, 62, 64) and waste knit. Replace sts at left back onto Ns and knit to match right side, reversing shapings.

NECKBAND

Join one shoulder by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. With right side facing, pick up 93 sts evenly along neck edge and place onto Ns. Using Con Col, T6 knit 1 row. Trans to rib and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH, T6 and knit 2 rows. Waste knit. Join second shoulder as first. Join neckband seam. Fold to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in Con Col.

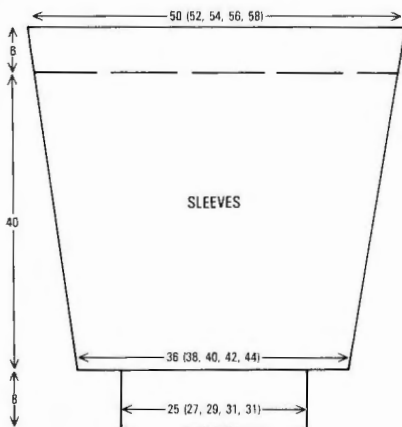

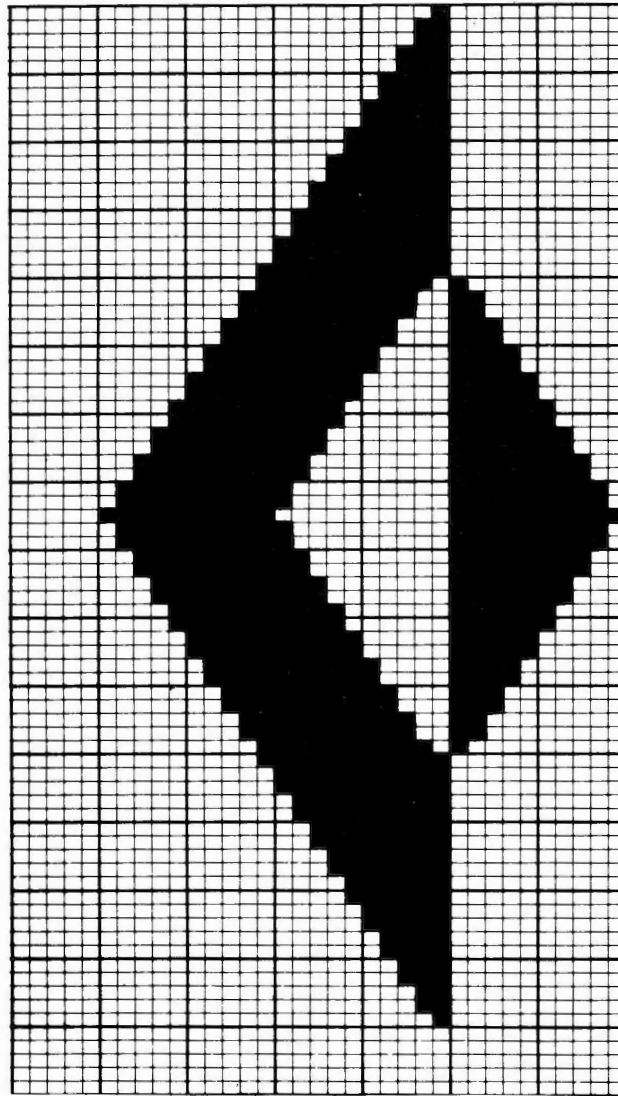
With wrong side facing, pick up 80 (83, 86, 90, 93) sts evenly along armhole edge, between markers, and place onto Ns, 000. Using Con Col knit to RC12, dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 12th row \times 11 and, AT THE SAME TIME, at RC14 change to M and knit to RC100. Waste knit. *Cuffs:* Push 41 (43, 47, 49, 53) Ns into WP. Place sts at cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. Using Con Col, T6 knit 1 row. Trans to rib, knit 20 rows and cast off loosely.

MAKE-UP

Block and press lightly. Join side and sleeve seams.

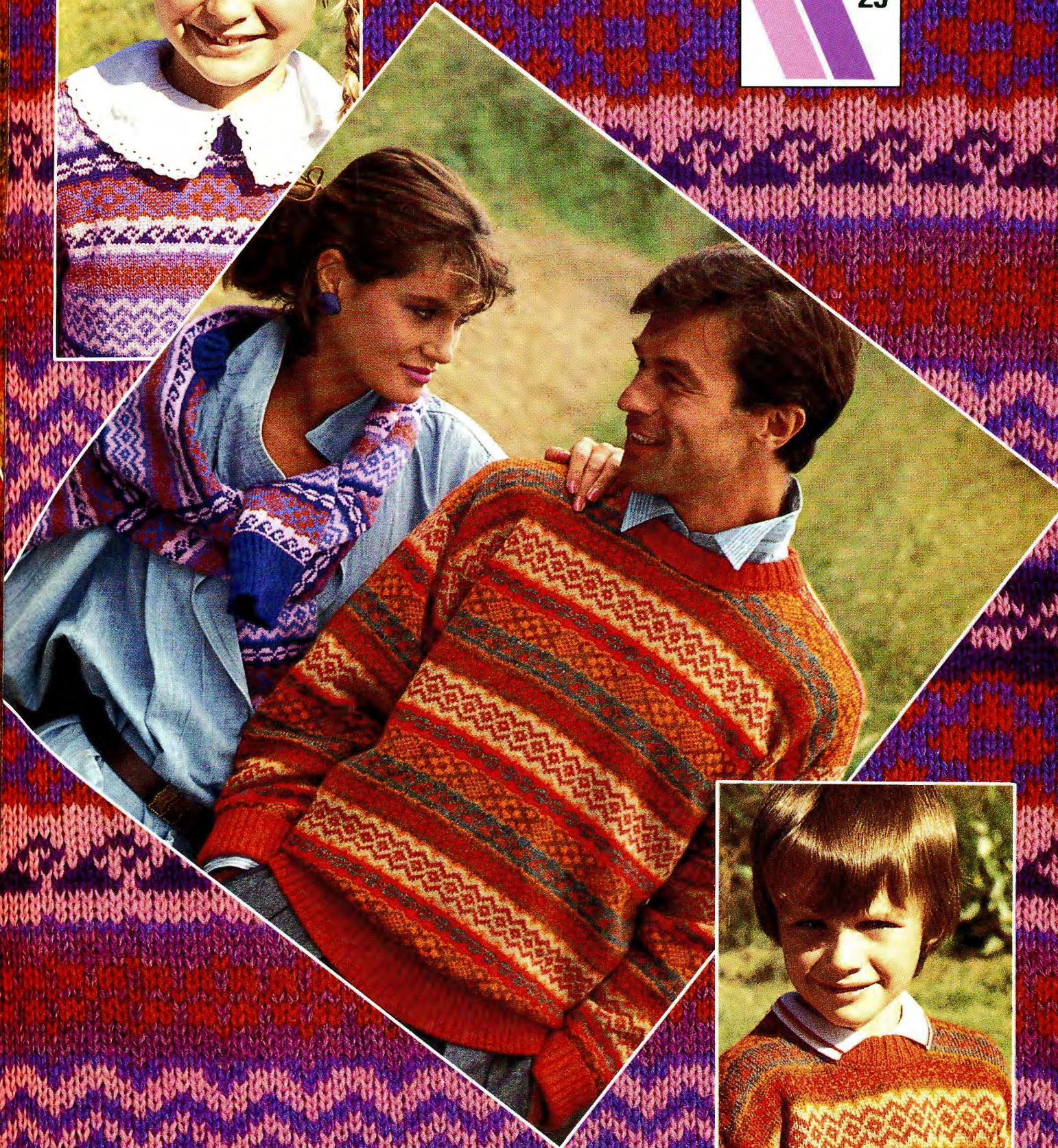








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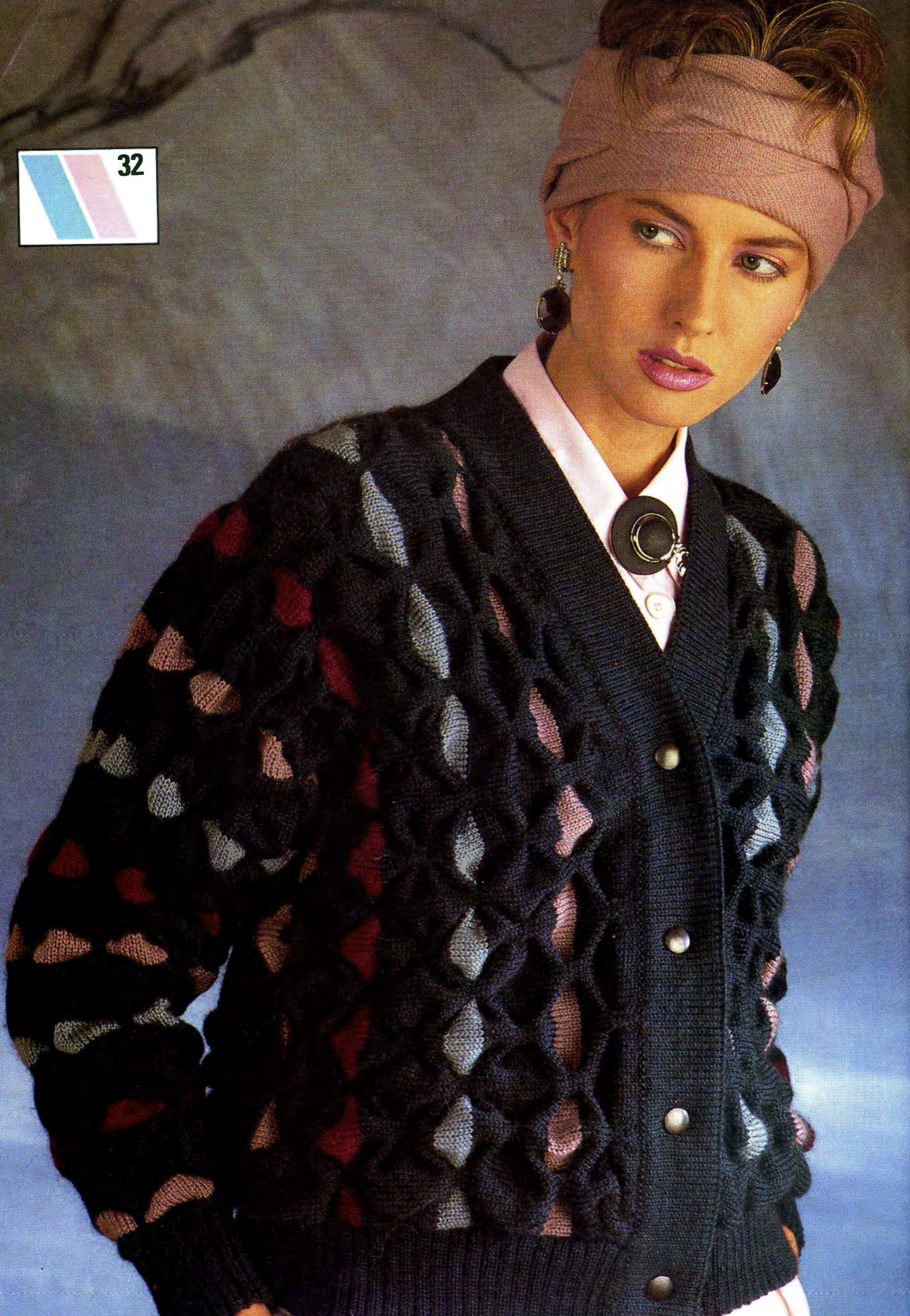
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
