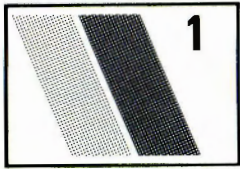
NOTES:

Success depends on working to correct tension.
Waste knit: Change to waste yarn, knit a few rows and release from machine.

- O = Orange (Left side of bed)



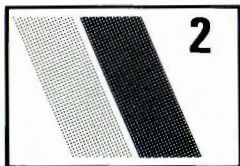


FRUIT INTARSIA SWEATER

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR, KL and Intarsia Carriage. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive DK; M - 250 (250, 260, 260, 270)g (Caribbean 6207), A - 50 (50, 60, 60, 70)g (Cordovan), B - 50 (50, 60, 60, 70)g (Yellow 6211), C - 100 (100, 110, 110, 120)g (Scarlet 6196), D - 130 (130, 140, 140, 150)g (Inca 6068), E - 40 (40, 50, 50, 60)g (Royal 6177), F - 40 (40, 50, 50, 60)g (Green 6209), G - 20 (20, 30, 30, 40)g (Snow White 6000), (50% acrylic 25% nylon 25% wool, 300m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 40 sts. = 14.8 cm and 60 rows = 18.6 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T5/5. **NOTES:** For diagram see Aeroplane Intarsia Sweater.

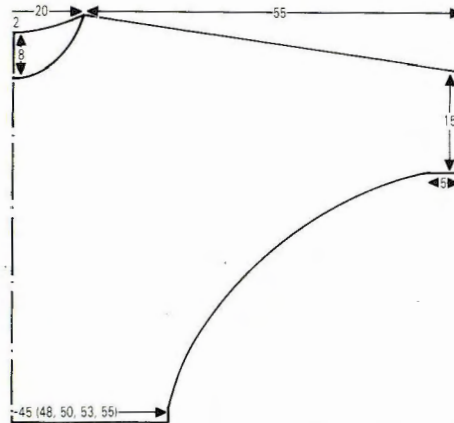
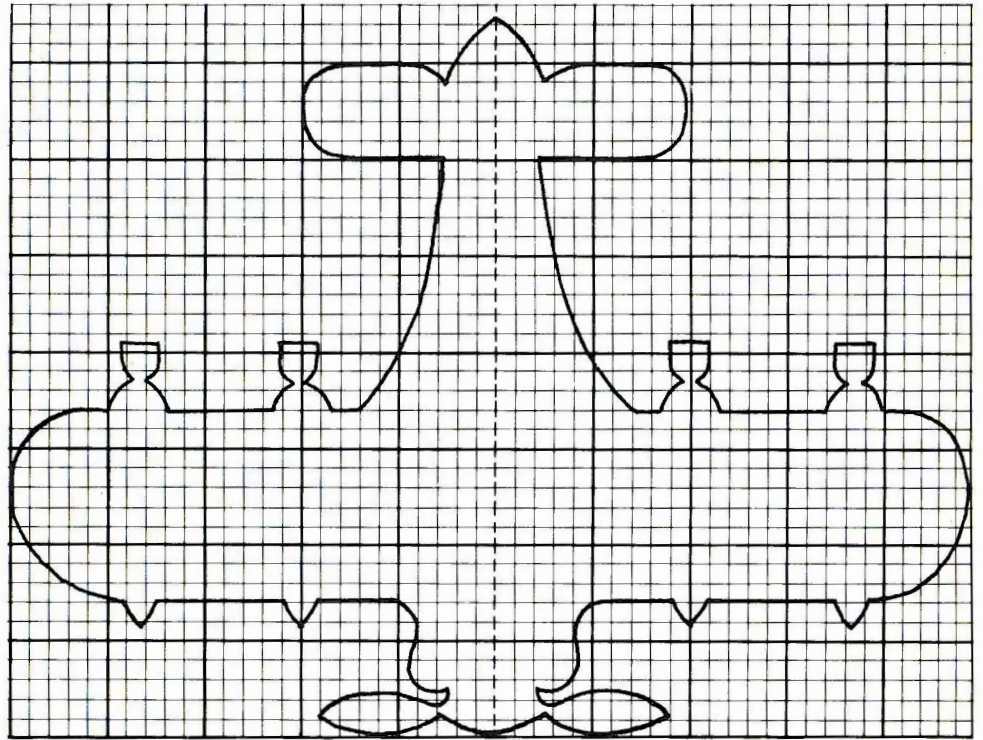
BACK/FRONT/SLEEVES

Make a tension swatch and set KL accordingly. Draw the garment shape in size required onto the KL sheet. Draw intarsia design onto the KL sheet. Begin and end at cuff edge in waste yarn. When FRONT/SLEEVE is complete, reverse the KL sheet for BACK/SLEEVE. Join one shoulder seam using mattress stitch. **Neckband:** Using M cast on 155 sts as RIB and knit 22 rows. Trans sts to KH. With wrong side facing pick up 155 sts evenly along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. Join second shoulder seam using mattress stitch. **Cuffs:** Using M cast on 63 sts as RIB and knit 26 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. **Waistbands:** Using M cast on 127 sts as RIB and knit 28 rows. Trans sts to KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts along waist edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. Join side and underarm seams using mattress stitch. Join neckband and turn to inside and slip stitch into position. Press according to yarn label. Embroider as illustrated.



AEROPLANE INTARSIA SWEATER

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR, KL (2 sheets required) and Intarsia Carriage. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive DK; M - 400 (410, 420, 430, 440)g (Royal 6177), A - 100 (110, 120, 130, 140)g (Yellow 6211), B - 150 (160, 170, 180, 190)g (Green 6209), C - 100 (110, 120, 130, 140)g (Fuchsia 6213), (50% acrylic 25% nylon 25% wool, 300m/

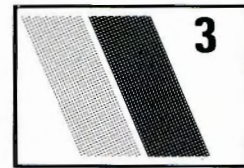


100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 40 sts = 14.6 cm and 60 rows = 18.4 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T5/5.

BACK/FRONT/SLEEVES

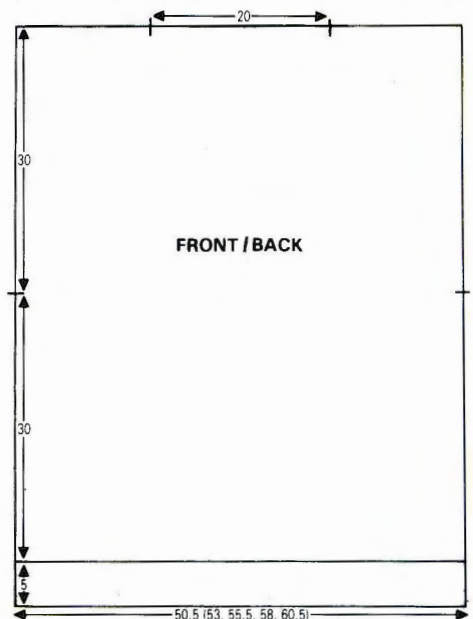
Make a tension swatch and set KL accordingly. Draw the garment shape in size required onto the KL sheet. Make an aeroplane template and use to draw around, placing it at different angles as illustrated. Begin and end at cuff edge in waste yarn. When FRONT/SLEEVES is complete, reverse KL sheets for BACK/SLEEVES. Join one shoulder seam using mattress stitch. **Neckband:** Using M cast on 155 sts as RIB and knit 22 rows. Trans sts to KH. With wrong side facing pick up 155 sts evenly along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. Join second shoulder seam using mattress stitch. **Cuffs:** Using M cast on 63 sts as RIB and knit 26 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. **Waistbands:** Using M cast on 127 sts as RIB and knit 28 rows. Trans sts to KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts along waist edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and

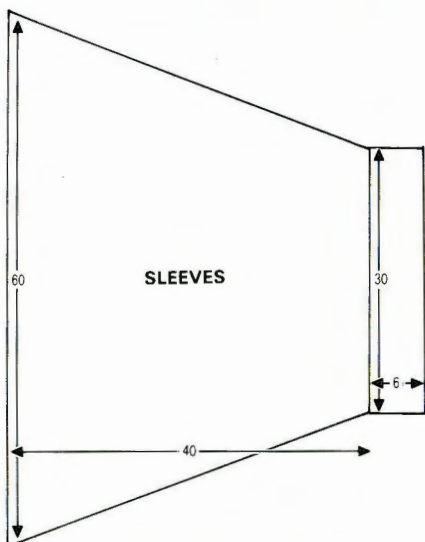
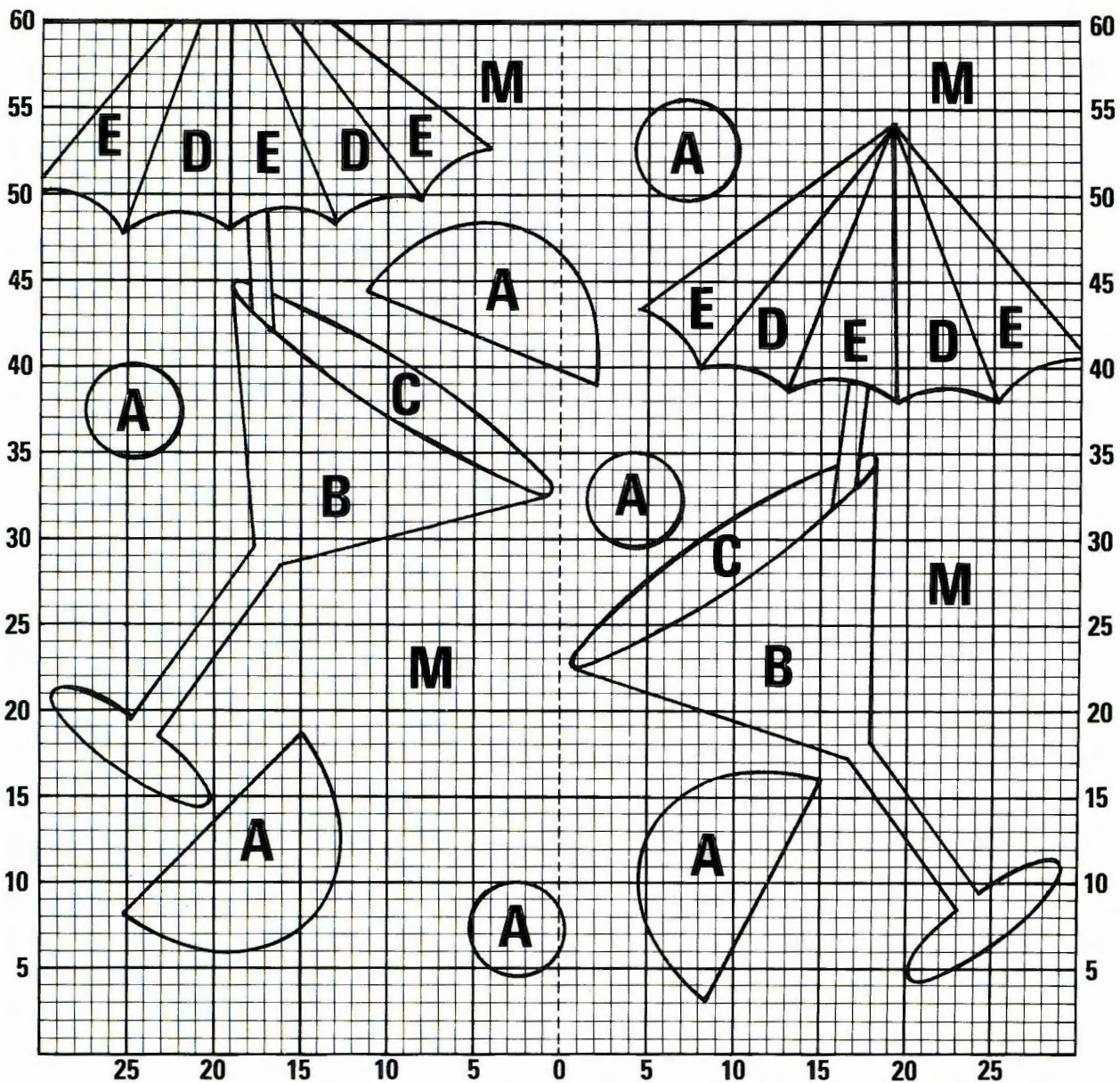
latch off. Join side and underarm seams using mattress stitch. Join neckband and turn to inside and slip stitch into position. Press according to yarn label.



COCKTAIL INTARSIA

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR, KL and Intarsia Carriage. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive DK; M - 350 (360, 370, 380, 400)g (Green 6209), A - 90 (100, 110, 120, 130)g (Scarlet 6196), B - 90 (100, 110, 120, 130)g (Snow White 6000), C - 40 (50, 60, 70, 80)g (Yellow 6211), D - 40 (50, 60, 70, 80)g (Caribbean 6207), E - 40 (50, 60, 70, 80)g





(Fuchsia 6213), (50% acrylic 25% nylon 25% wool, 300m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 40 sts = 14.8 cm and 60 rows = 18.6 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T5/5.

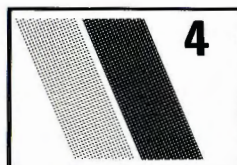
BACK/FRONT SLEEVES

Make a tension swatch and set KL accordingly. Draw BACK/FRONT garment

shape onto KL sheet and then draw in COCKTAIL design. Draw SLEEVE inside BACK/FRONT. **Waistbands:** Cast on required number of sts as RIB and knit 26 rows. **Neckband:** Trans to RIB, knit 13 rows and cast off. **Cuffs:** Cast on required number of sts as RIB and knit 26 rows.

MAKE-UP

Join side, sleeve and shoulder seams, embroider as illustrated. Press according to yarn label.

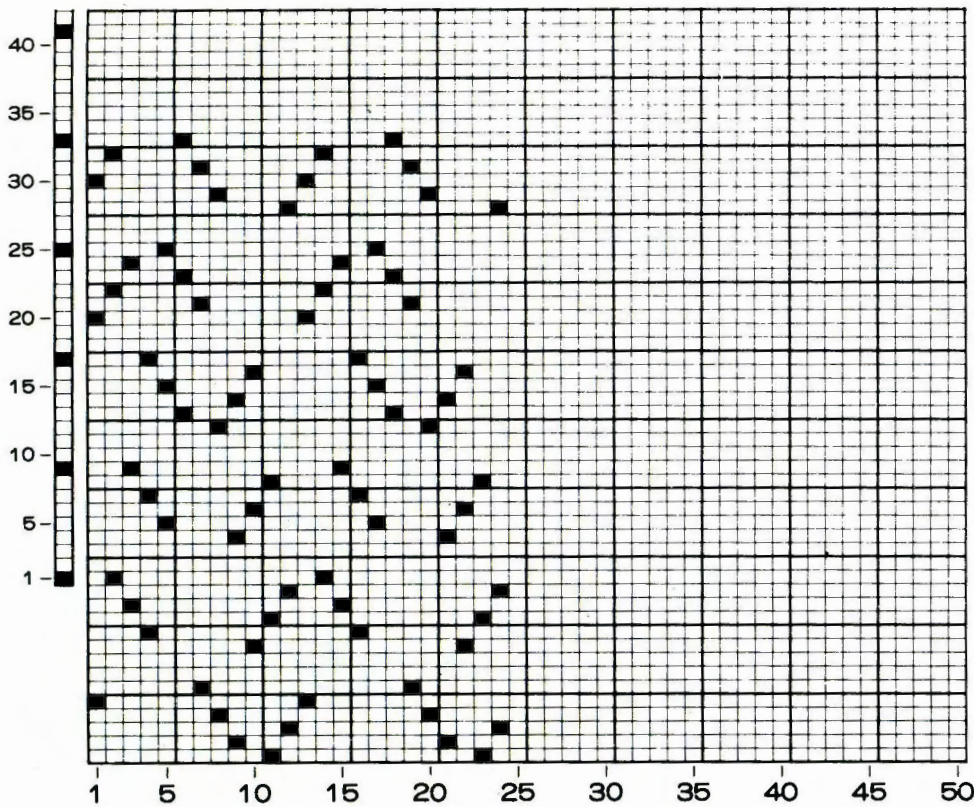


LADY'S "SAMPLER" SWEATER

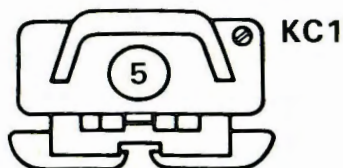
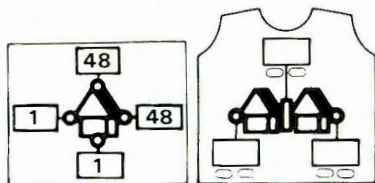
MACHINES: C and those A machines with L-Point Cams and KR. **MATERIALS:** F.W. BRAMWELL and CO. LTD, Artistic; M - 375 (400, 425, 450, 475)g (White) (100% acrylic 450m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106)cm.

TENSION: Work tension swatch over 72 sts (3 patt repeats) and 72 rows (2 patt repeats) - 40 sts = 13.3 cm and 60 rows = 13.3 cm (approx T5). **RIBS:** 1 x 1 T0/0. **NOTES:** 'C' machines enter programs 1 and 2 alternately every 36 rows. 'A' machines with L-Point Cams - use Cams to block every alt 24 st patt repeat - see diagram. All sts which are not included in a 24 patt repeat at each end of work are left as lace sts.

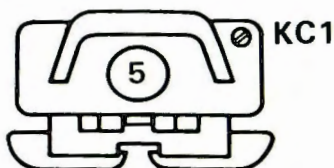
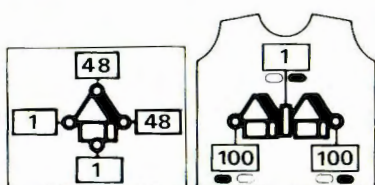
To work first 36 rows of patt: Cable/bobble row is worked on rows 6, 12, 18, 24 and 30 of each patt repeat. Cables are worked 2 over 2 sts, bobbles are worked over 3 sts. 'C' machines enter program as given, 'A' machines with L-Point-Cams place Cams into position, 000. Work lace to RC6, COR. Operate the L-Carr to trans the sts. Foll Chart A, work cables. Foll Chart B work bobbles as folls: Disconnect RC. Push all Ns left of first bobble position to HP. Set K-Carr to H. Knit 1 row, COL. Push all Ns to right of first bobble position to HP. Knit 7 rows. *COR. Pick up centre st of row before bobble and place onto Ns above. Determine the next bobble position. Take back to WP Ns up to and including the 3 next bobble Ns. Knit 1 row, COL. Push all Ns at right of the next to HP. Knit 7 rows*. Rep from * to *



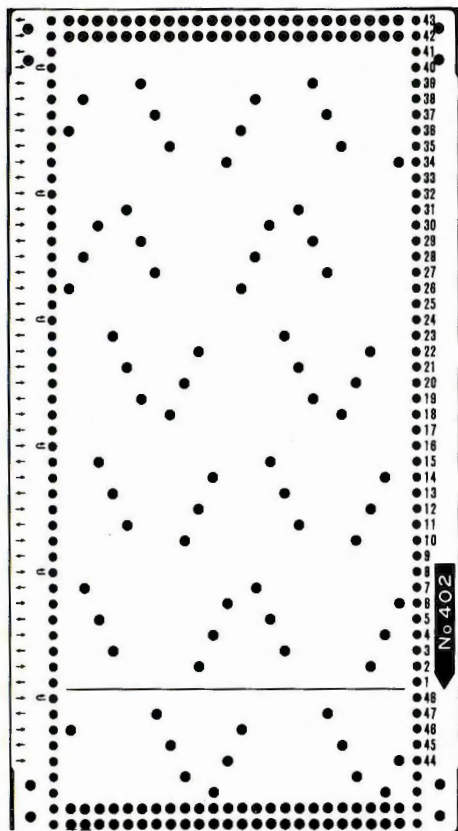

until all bobbles have been worked, COL. Set RC 1 row ahead. Reconnect RC and knit in lace to next cable/bobble row. When one patt repeat is completed, reposition the L-Point Cams or reprogram.



BACK/FRONT

Insert card or program first patt repeat. Using M cast on 151 (159, 167, 175, 181) sts as RIB and knit 40 rows. Trans to KH, 000. Inc 1 st. T5 work in lace/cable/bobble patt to RC108. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Cont in patt to RC204, COR.

Neck shaping

Using Nylon Cast-on Thread, knit back to NWP 111 (115, 119, 123, 126) sts at left. 41 (45, 49, 53, 56) sts left in WP. Cont in patt, knit 1 row, COL. At beg of next and every

full alt row cast off 2 sts x 5. Knit to RC216 and waste knit. Return 41 (45, 49, 53, 56) Ns at left to WP and knit to match right side reversing shapings.

Neckband

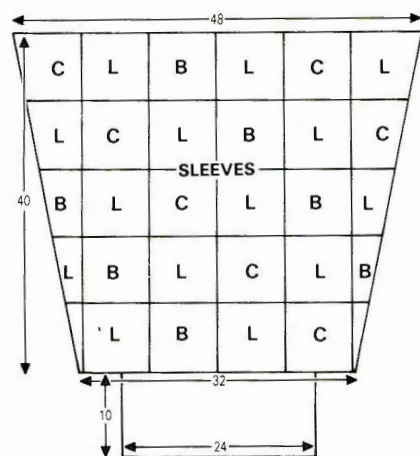
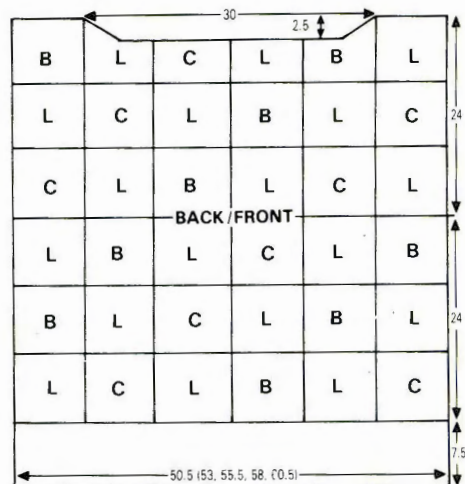
Return rem Ns to WP. Pick up 14 sts along cast-off edge each side and place onto Ns. T5 knit 1 row. Trans to 1 x 1 rib T3/3, 000. Knit 1 row. Decrease tension by 1/3 every row to RC8. T8/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

SLEEVES

Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Join neckband seams. With wrong side facing pick up 146 sts evenly along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns, 000. T5 work in lace/cable/bobble patt to RC3. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 7th row x 25. Knit to RC180 and waste knit rem 96 sts. Cuffs: Block and press LIGHTLY on wrong side. Push 73 Ns into WP. With wrong side facing replace sts onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row, 000. T5 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, knit to RC49, T8/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

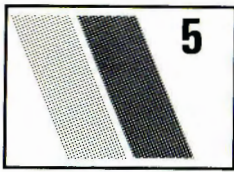

Join side and sleeve seams.

MAN'S/LADY'S ENGLISH RIB SWEATER

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** F.W. BRAMWELL and CO. LTD Artistic; M - 460 (480, 500, 520, 540)g (White), A - 160 (170, 180, 190, 200)g (Silver), B - 95 (100, 105, 110, 115)g (Light Green) (100% acrylic 450m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit chest/bust 91 (96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** English rib - 40 sts = 13 cm and 60 rows = 8.7 cm (approx T2 $\frac{1}{3}$ /2 $\frac{1}{3}$). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T0/0. **NOTES:** Stripe sequence: *using M knit 32 rows, A - 8 rows, M - 20 rows, A - 16 rows, B - 8 rows*, rep from * to * throughout.

BACK/FRONT

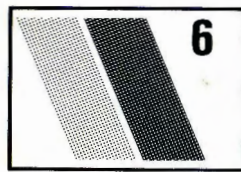
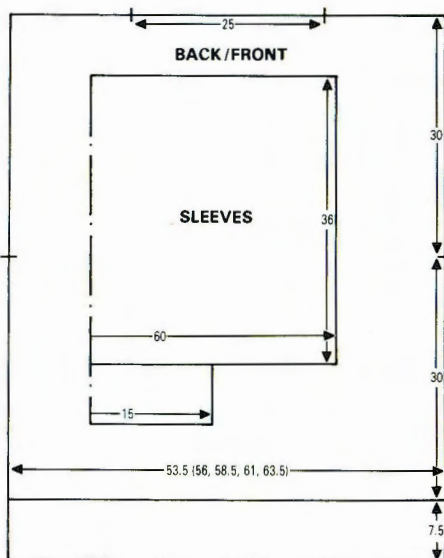
Using M cast on 161 (169, 175, 183, 191) sts as RIB and knit 30 rows, 000. Set for English Rib and working in stripe sequence T2 $\frac{1}{3}$ /2 $\frac{1}{3}$ knit to RC210. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Knit to RC420, 000. Change to M and RIB, knit to RC14. T6/6 knit 1 row. T0/0 knit to RC30. Trans sts to KH. Pick up sts from first row knitted in RIB and place picked up sts onto Ns. T4 knit 1 row and cast off.

SLEEVES

Join shoulder seams leaving an opening of approx 25 cm. With wrong side facing pick up 181 sts evenly along armhole edge between markers and place onto Ns. T6 knit 1 row. Trans to English rib, 000. T2 $\frac{1}{3}$ /2 $\frac{1}{3}$ and working stripe sequence in reverse knit to RC252. Trans all sts to KH, T4 knit 1 row and waste knit. **Cuffs:** Push 91 Ns on KH to WP. With wrong side facing place sts from last row knitted in M onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, knit 30 rows, T6/6 knit 1 row. Trans sts to KH and latch off.

MAKE-UP

Join side and sleeve seams



SWEATER SUIT

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR (KR with plating facility). **MATERIALS:** ATKINSONS MAIL ORDER YARNS Pearl; Sweater - M - 450 (475, 500, 525, 550)g (White). Skirt - 170 (180, 190, 200, 210)g (White), Con Col - Sweater 20 g, Skirt - 170 (180, 190, 200, 210)g (Apple), (70% cotton, 30% viscose 750m/100g), 1 button, elastic to fit waist + 2.5 cm. **MEASUREMENTS:** Sweater to fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm; Skirt to fit hips 91 (96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** Sweater - using 2 ends of M together - st st - 40 sts = 13.6 cm and 60 rows = 15.8 cm (approx T7). Skirt - rib patt - 40 sts = 14.2 cm and 60 rows = 15.6 cm (approx T6/4). **RIB:** Sweater 1 × 1 T4/4 (using 2 ends of Col Col work first row of cast-on then change to 2 ends of M to complete). Skirt - plating - with 1 end of Col Col in FA and 1 end of M in plating feeder.

BACK

Cast on 149 (157, 165, 171, 179) sts as RIB (see RIB) and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T7 knit to RC152. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC92. Waste knit centre 59 sts. Waste knit rem 45 (49, 53, 56, 60) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

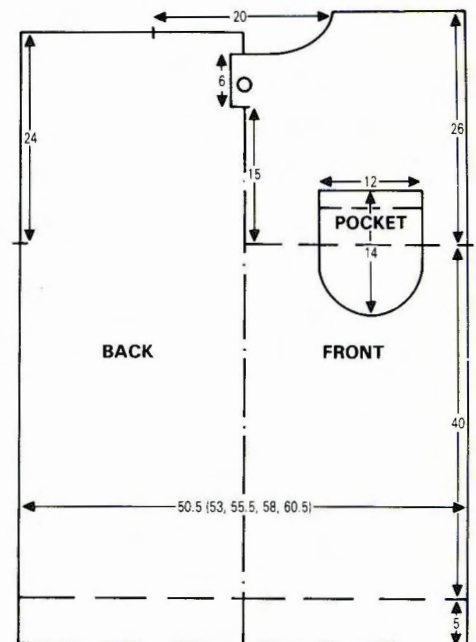
As BACK from * to *. At right of needle bed trans sts 35 and 50 to adjacent Ns. **Take empty Ns back to NWP. ***Knit 7 rows. Push the empty Ns to WP. Knit 1 row. Drop the loop caught on Ns 35 and 50 and return the Ns to NWP. Working from left to right, from the empty N, cable the next 6 sts, 3 over 3, take the left hand sts over the right hand sts. Working from right to left, from the empty N cable the next 6 sts, 3 over 3, taking the right hand sts over the left hand sts.*** Rep from *** to ***, ** working to RC152. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Bring empty Ns to WP. Knit to RC14. At left of needle bed trans sts 36 and 51 to adjacent Ns. Rep from ** to ** and, AT THE SAME TIME at RC 56, COR, work ...

Neck opening

Waste knit 70 (74, 78, 81, 85) sts at left. Knit 1 row, COL. Cast on 9 sts at beg of next row. Knit to RC68, working from left to right, leave first 3 sts, make a buttonhole over next 3 sts, leave next 6 sts, make a buttonhole over next 3 sts. Knit to RC77, COL.

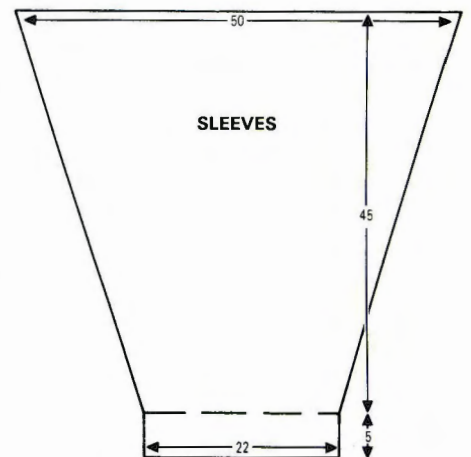
Neck shaping

At beg of next and alt rows cast off 10 sts × 1, 6 sts × 1, 4 sts × 1, 3 sts × 2, 2 sts × 3, 1 st × 2. Knit to RC98 and waste knit rem 45 (49, 53, 56, 60) sts. Replace sts from left side back onto Ns. Set RC to 56, COR. Cast on 18 sts at beg of next row and knit to match right side reversing shaping and omitting buttonholes.



SLEEVES

Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Cast on 65 sts as rib (see RIB) T2/2 and knit 22 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T7 knit 2 rows. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 41, and AT THE SAME TIME knit to RC166, change to Con Col and knit to RC170. Waste knit, turn work and replace sts back onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up 147 sts from armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

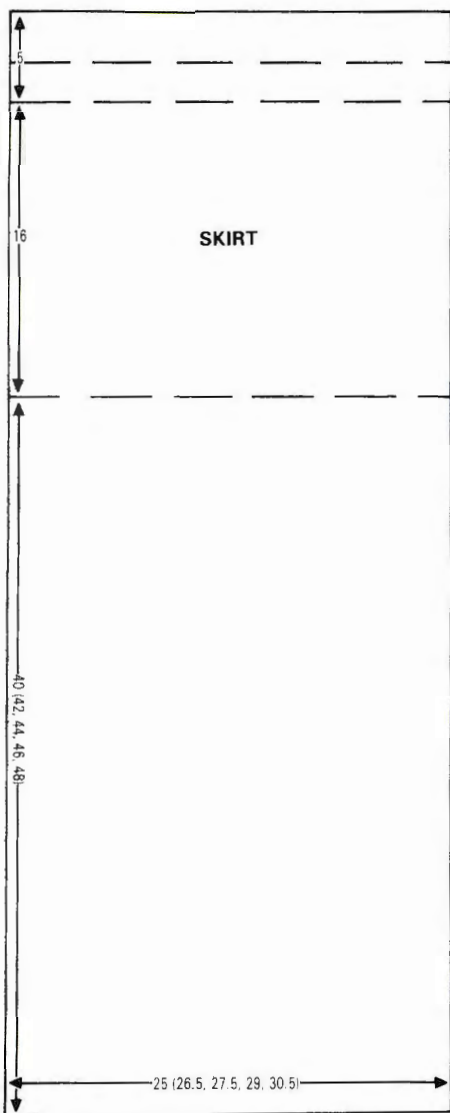


POCKET

Cast on 35 sts as rib (see RIB) and knit 8 rows. Trans to KH, T7, 000. Knit to RC32. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row × 3, then every row × 5. Cast off.

COLLAR

Cast on 133 sts as RIB (see RIB), 000. T4/4 knit 4 rows. *Dec tension by $\frac{1}{3}$, knit 4 rows*, rep from * to * to RC20. At left push 55 Ns into HP. Knit 1 row, at right push 55 Ns into HP. Knit 1 row. ***At left push 6 inside Ns to WP, knit 1 row. At right push 6 inside Ns to WP, knit 1 row.*** Rep from *** to *** × 6. Push all rem Ns at left in HP to WP, knit 1 row. Push all rem Ns at right in HP to WP, knit 1 row. Trans all sts to KH. Place a WY marker 13 sts from each end of neck edge.

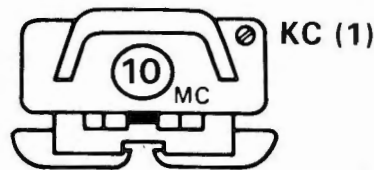
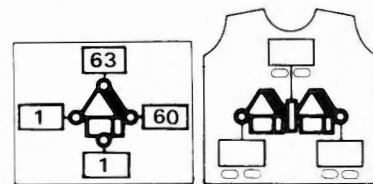


LADY'S FAIRISLE SWEATER

MACHINES: C with KR. **MATERIALS:** LAINES ANNY BLATT Angor'anny; M - 230 (240, 250, 260, 270)g (Blanc) (70% angora 30% wool 450m/100g), JAEGER Monte Cristo; A - 210 (220, 230, 240, 250)g (Royal 120), B - 200 (210, 220, 230, 240)g (Jade 119), (50% cotton 50% acrylic 212m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle patt - 40 sts = 14.9 cm and 60 rows = 18.5 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T4/4. **NOTES:** Working in fairisle stripes as illustrated, and with M in FA throughout, change yarn in FB on rows 1 and 31.

BACK/FRONT

Using WY cast on 146 (152, 160, 166, 172) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR, 000. *Change to M T10 knit 1 row. PROGRAM for fairisle, set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns. With M in FA and A in FB, work in fairisle stripes (see NOTES)* to RC72. Place a WY marker at each end of



work. Knit to RC158. Change to st st and M only and knit 2 rows, 000. Trans to RIB, knit to RC11, T6/6 knit 1 row, T4/4 knit to RC24. Trans to KH, pick up sts from last row knitted in M and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Waist ribs:** Push 116 (122, 130, 136, 142) Ns into WP. With wrong side facing place sts from waist edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, 000. Knit to RC31, T8/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off. Join shoulders leaving 25 cm neck opening.

SLEEVES

Using WY cast on 100 sts and knit a few rows ending with COR, 000. Work from * to

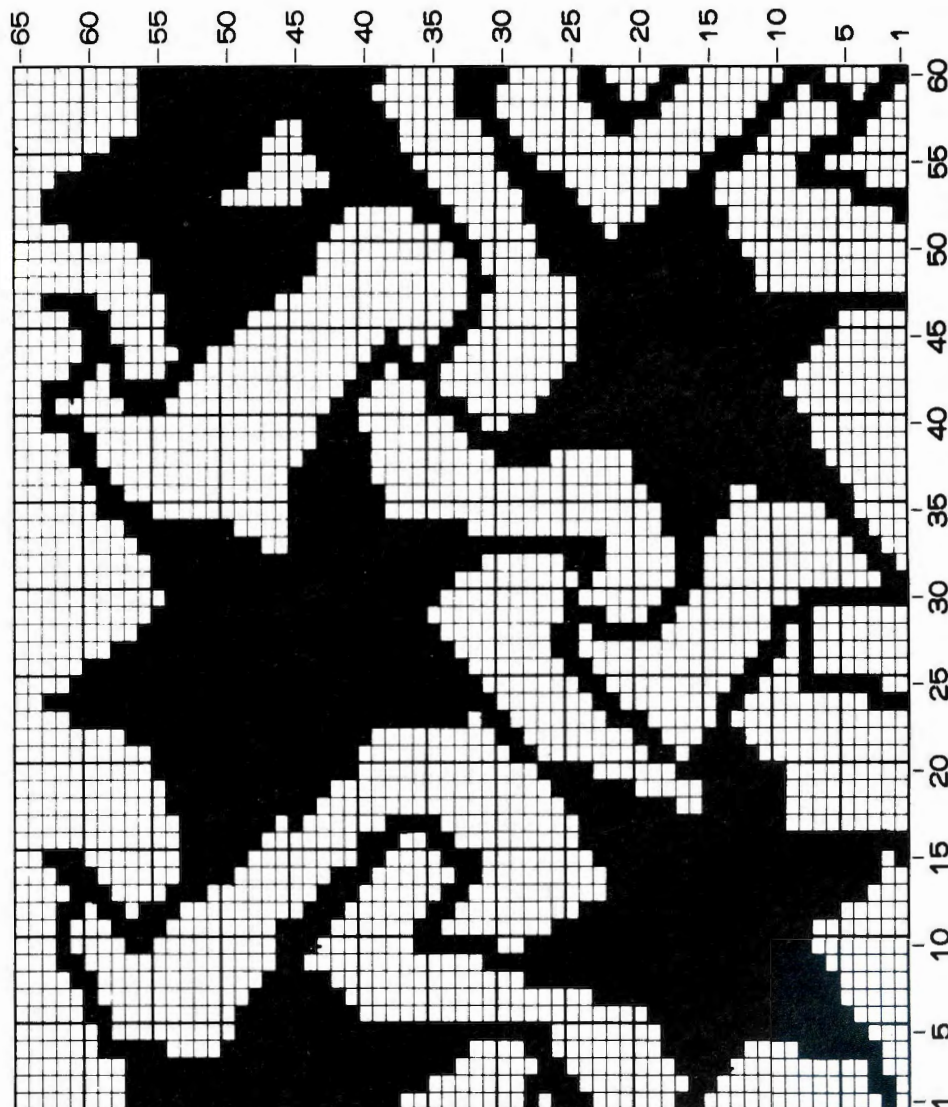
Join side, sleeve and neckband seams. Back-stitch outside of neckband into position. Join pocket bag. Stitch pocket trim into position.

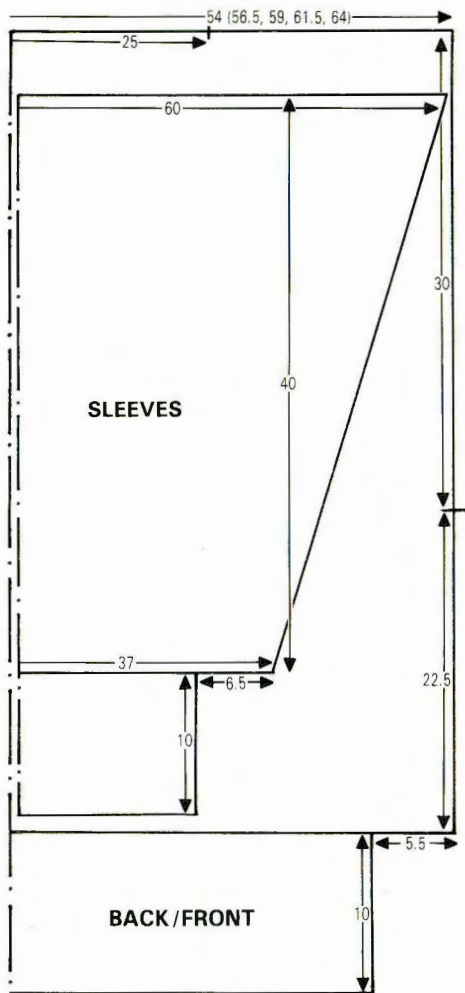
SKIRT (4 pieces alike)

Using M cast on 110 (116, 122, 128, 134) sts as rib and knit to RC156 (164, 172, 180, 188), 000. Pitch Lever to P. Trans sts as for 1 × 1 rib, T5/5, knit 22 rows, T4/4 knit 22 rows, T3/3 knit 22 rows. Trans to KH. T6 knit 12 rows. T10 knit 1 row. T6 knit 12 rows. Cast off loosely.

MAKE-UP

Using mattress stitch, join skirt pieces. Fold waistband in half along 'foldline' to inside and catch down encasing elastic.

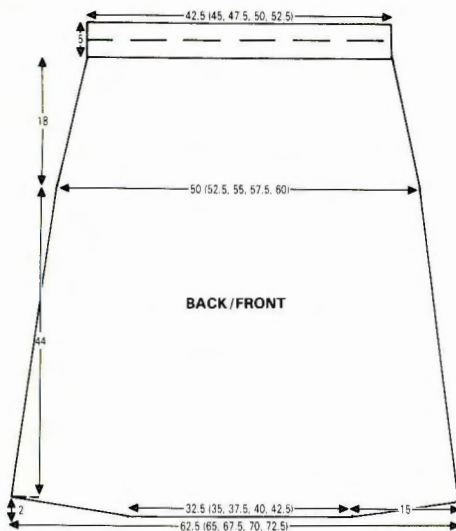




101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** Tuck st - 40 sts = 16.6 cm and 60 rows = 9.3 cm (approx T8). **NOTES:** Instructions are given for machines without KG-88; however, if you are using the KG-88, COBH required number of sts and knit 6 rows (1 row plain, 1 row purl) before commencing patt. Ns on KH are counted as sts throughout.

SKIRT BACK AND FRONT

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M COBH 150 (156, 162, 168, 174) sts. Set K-Carr to KC, T8 knit 1 row. COL. Release card, depress both TUCK buttons, set K-Carr to H. *At side opposite K-carr push 36 Ns into HP, knit 1 row*, rep from * to *. On next and every row at side opposite K-carr take 5 inside Ns back to WP \times 12, then 6 Ns \times 2, 000. Knit to RC17. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 17th row \times 15, then next and every foll 13th row \times 9. Knit to RC404, 000. Change to T6 and st st, knit to RC12. T10 knit 1 row. T6 knit to RC25. Cast off rem 102 (108, 114, 120, 126) sts loosely.

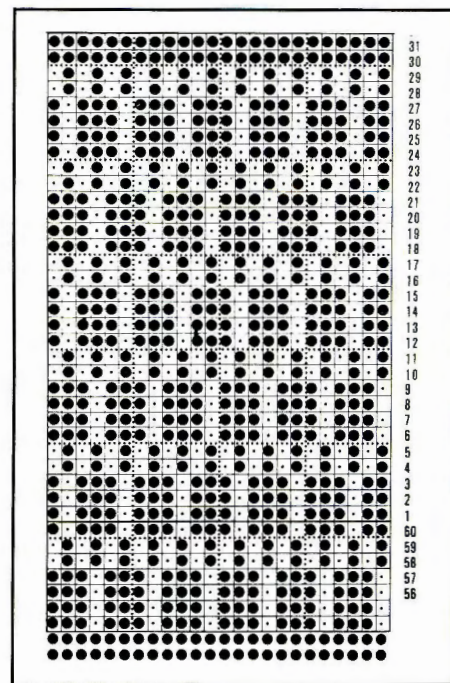
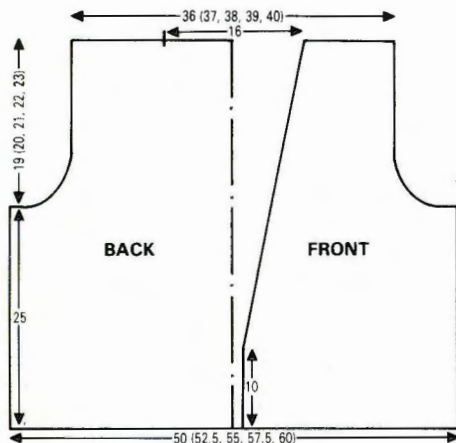


MAKE-UP

Join side seams. Work 2 rows of crochet along hem. Fold waistband in half to inside and catch down encasing elastic. Press lightly.

JACKET BACK

Lock card on row 1. Using M COBH 120 (126, 132, 138, 144) sts. T8 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in tuck to RC162, 000.



Armhole shaping

At beg of next and every row cast off 4 sts \times 2, 3 sts \times 2, 2 sts \times 4, then dec 1 st at each end of alt rows \times 6 (8, 9, 11, 13). Knit to RC124 (130, 136, 144, 150). Waste knit 24 (25, 27, 28, 29) sts at each side of work for shoulders. Cast off rem 38 sts for back neck.

RIGHT FRONT

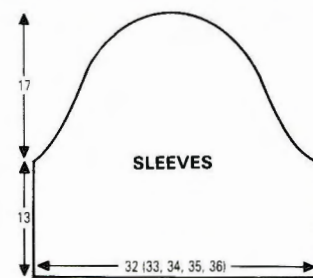
Lock card on row 1. Using M COBH 58 (60, 64, 68, 70) sts. T8 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in tuck to RC65, COL.

Neck shaping

At right dec 1 st on next and every foll 13th row \times 17 (16, 17, 18, 17) and AT THE SAME TIME at RC162, 000, shape armholes as BACK. Knit to RC124 (130, 136, 144, 150) and waste knit.

LEFT FRONT

As RIGHT FRONT reversing shapings.



SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Using M COBH 77 (79, 81, 85, 87) sts. T8 knit 1 row, 000. Release card and work in tuck to RC84, 000.

Sleeve head shaping

At beg of next and every row cast off 3 sts \times 2, 2 sts \times 2, then dec 1 st at each end of alt rows \times 5, then every 4th row \times 22, then every alt row \times 4. Knit 2 rows. Cast off rem 5 (7, 9, 13, 15) sts.

COLLAR

Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Using

* as BACK/FRONT. Knit to RC12. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row \times 27. Knit to RC126. Change to st st and M only, knit 2 rows. Waste knit, turn work and place last row knitted in M onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up 154 sts between WY markers along armhole edge and place onto same Ns. Using M T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Cuff:** Push 66 Ns into WP. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, 000. Knit to RC31, T8/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

MAKE-UP

Press lightly, join side and sleeve seams.



LADY'S TUCK SUIT

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR (KG-88 optional). **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive 4-ply; SKIRT - M - 340 (350, 360, 370, 380)g, JACKET - M - 250 (275, 300, 325, 350)g (Black 4194), Con Col - 50 g approx (Ecrú 4002), (25% nylon, 50% acrylic, 25% wool, 434 m/100g). 3 buttons. Elastic to fit waist. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm and hips 91 (96,

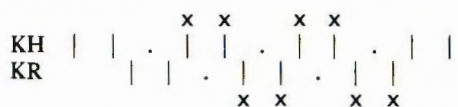
Con Col cast on 109 (112, 115, 118, 121) sts as FNR, then trans sts as N arrangement:



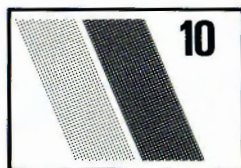
T6/4 knit 15 rows, COL. At right, push 21 (24, 27, 30, 33) Ns to HP, knit 2 rows. At right on next and every foll alt row, push 4 inside Ns to HP x 22. Return all Ns to WP. Trans to KH, T8 knit 2 rows. With right side facing pick up 109 (112, 115, 118, 121) sts from beg of neck shaping to centre back neck and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join side and sleeve seams. Set in sleeves. Work 2 rows of crochet along cuff edge and waist edge. Press LIGHTLY. *Buttonband:* Using Con Col cast on 11 sts as FNR, then trans sts as N arrangement:



T4/4 *knit 12 rows, cable centre KH sts (marked with *) 2 over 2*, rep from * to * working to RC196 (200, 204, 208, 212) and cast off. Attach to right FRONT. *Buttonhole band:* Using Con Col cast on as Buttonband. **Knit 6 rows. Make a 2 st buttonhole over the centre Ns on KR, knit 6 rows. Cable KR sts (marked with *) 2 over 2**, rep from ** to ** x 3. Working cables only knit to RC100 and cast off. Stitch into position along left FRONT and edge of collar. *Mock pocket trims:* Work as Buttonband to RC60 and cast off. Stitch into position. Attach buttonband and buttons.



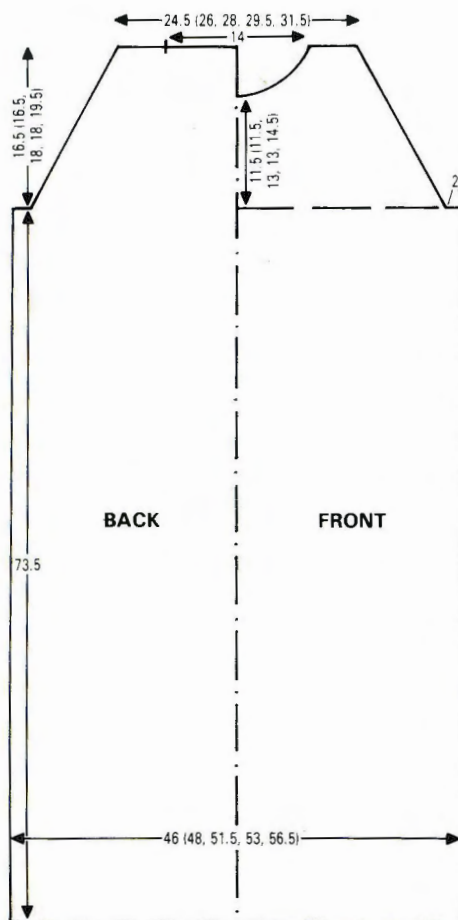

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive 4-ply; M - 450 (475, 500, 525, 550)g (4000 Snow White) (50% acrylic 25% nylon 25% wool, 434m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** 2 x 2 rib cable patt, Pitch lever to H - 40 sts = 11.7 cm and 60 rows = 15 cm (approx T5/5). **NOTES:** When measuring tension swatch stretch fabric slightly.

N arrangement:



Cast on as N arrangement. Ensure that the end Ns are on KH. **Knit 6 rows. Cable 2 over 2 Ns marked with *, knit 6 rows, cable 2 over 2 Ns marked with o**. Rep from ** to ** throughout. When shaping count Ns on KH as sts throughout.



BACK

Using M cast on 157 (163, 175, 181, 193) sts, 000. Work in cable patt - see notes - to RC294, 000.

Armhole shaping



Trans sts on Ns marked * onto Ns marked o then move rem end sts to close space.

Cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC6. Dec 3 sts at each end of next and every foll 6th row x 10 (10, 11, 11, 12). Knit to RC66 (66, 72, 72, 78). Waste knit centre 47 sts. Waste knit rem 18 (21, 24, 27, 30) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

As BACK to RC46 (46, 52, 52, 58) above armhole shaping.

Neck shaping

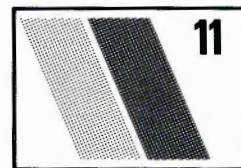

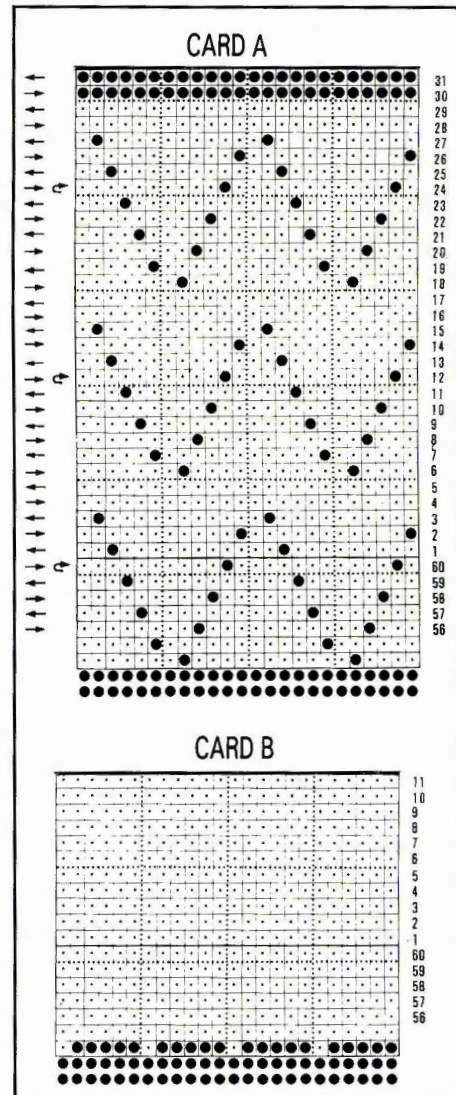

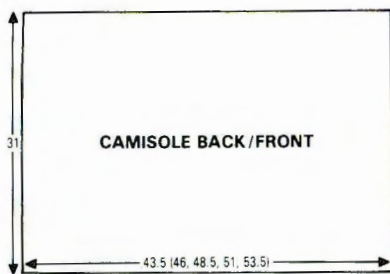

Tuck - 40 sts = 13.3 cm and 60 rows = 14.3 cm (approx T5). **NOTES:** Jacket stripe sequence - *8 rows M, 4 rows A, 2 rows B, * rep from * to * throughout.





CAMISOLE BACK/FRONT

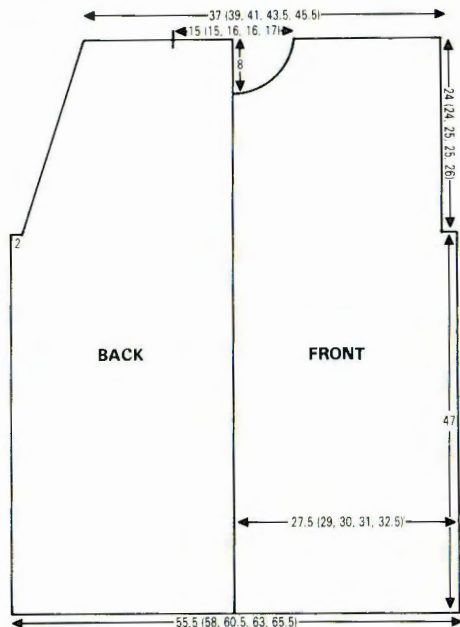

Armhole shaping

Cast off 5 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC3. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 3rd row \times 23 (23, 24, 24, 25). Cont in lace/stripe patt to RC72 (72, 76, 76, 78). Waste knit 33 (36, 38, 41, 43) sts each side for shoulders. Cast off centre 45 (46, 48, 49, 51) sts for back neck.

RIGHT FRONT

Lock card on row 1. Using WY cast on 83 (87, 91, 94, 98) sts and knit approx 5 cm. Change to M, 000. COBH 83 (87, 91, 94, 98) sts. T5 knit 2 rows. Release card and work in lace/stripe patt (see NOTES) throughout, knit to RC142, 000.

Armhole shaping

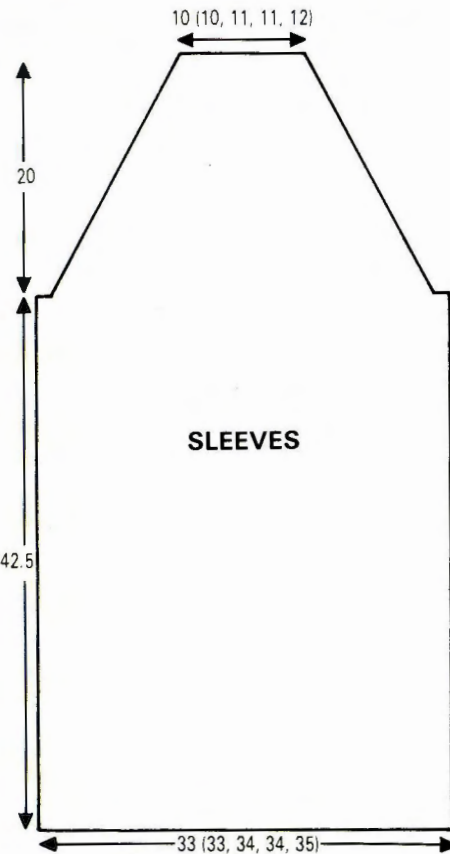

ATKINSON MAIL ORDER YARNS Lurex; Lace Thread - 50 (50, 50, 60, 60)g (Silver) (100% Lurex), LAINES ANNY BLATT Serpentine; decorative ribbon - approx 1 metre, shoulder pads. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Thread Lace patt - 20 sts = 12.5 cm and 30 rows = 11.1 cm (approx T2). **RIB:** Using A, B or C with KR - 2 \times 2 T5/5. **NOTES:** Use card 14P from basic pack. Cancel end needle selection (see Instruction Manual) and return any end needles selected back to WP. Use M in FA and 2 ends of metallic thread in FB throughout Thread Lace Patt. Use M and 1 end of metallic thread for ribs.

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using WY cast on 81 (85, 89, 93, 97) sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. T2 with M in FA set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row, 000. Using 2 ends of metallic thread in FB, set K-Carr for Thread Lace, release card and knit to RC56. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. * Knit to RC80. Using a separate length



of M, cast off centre 29 sts for back neck. Waste knit rem 26 (28, 30, 32, 34) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

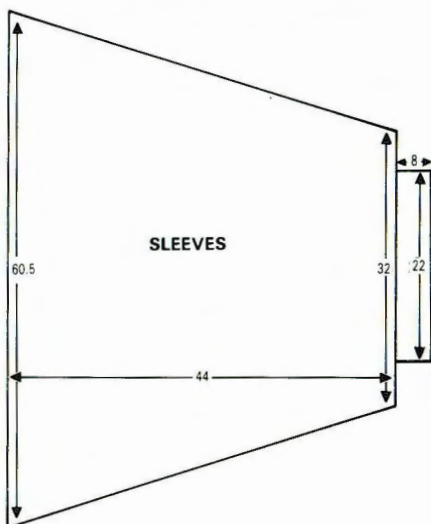

Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Using a separate length of M, cast off centre 5 sts, waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and foll alt rows, cast off 3 sts \times 1, 2 sts \times 2, then dec 1 st \times 5. Knit to RC84 and waste knit rem 26 (28, 30, 32, 34) sts. Replace sts at left back onto Ns. Lock card on row 1. With WY cast on 51 sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. T2 using M in FA set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row, 000. Using 2 ends of metallic thread in FB set K-Carr for Thread Lace, release card and knit to RC3. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row \times 23. Knit to RC120 and waste knit 97 sts. Turn work and replace last patt row onto Ns. With wrong side facing



pick up sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns. T10 with M only knit 1 row and cast off.

NECKBAND

Using WY cast on 20 sts and knit a few rows, 000. T2 with M and 2 ends of metallic thread together in FA knit in st st to RC212 (218, 224, 228, 234) and waste knit.

WAIST RIBS

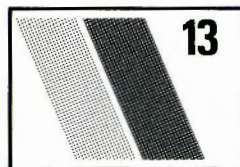
Using M and 1 end of metallic thread together, and A, B or C machines with KR, cast on 134 (142, 150, 158, 166) sts as 2 \times 2 rib and knit to RC100. Trans to KH. CUFFS

As WAIST RIBS using 66 sts and knitting 36 rows.

MACHINES: A or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** PINGOUIN Perle No 5; M - 450 (475, 500, 525, 550)g (07 Coquelicot) (100% cotton 400m/100g); LAINES ANNY BLATT Angor'anny; A - 50g (Turo 641) (70% angora 30% wool, 450m/100g); SILVERKNIT YARNS Pearl; B - 100g (Shade 1294) (100% viscose, 450m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Lace - 40 sts = 16.6 cm and 60 rows = 15 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T3/3. **NOTES:** A machines, use card illustrated and return selected Ns to WP over 14 sts centre panel, 6 neck edge sts, 10 sleeve top sts and 4 cuff edge sts. C machines, use Pattern Sheet 9 from basic set. The following sts are dropped, laddered to first row of lace, then latched up to form a purl st: centre panel - 2nd and 3rd sts from edges; top of sleeve - 8th and 9th sts from edge of work.

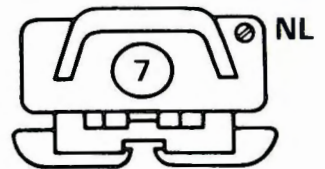
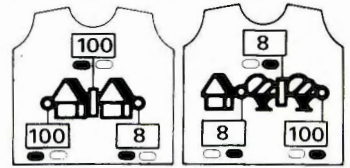
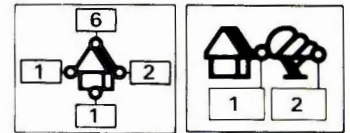

BACK/FRONT/SLEEVES

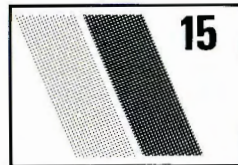
Make a tension swatch and set KL accordingly. Draw the garment shape in size required onto the KL sheet. Draw intarsia design onto KL sheet. **BACK** - begin with WY and knit a few rows. Work in intarsia to the neck/shoulder line, waste knit neckline sts, then waste knit shoulder sts. **FRONT** - work as **BACK** reversing the KL sheet and casting off for neckline shaping. Join one shoulder by placing one set of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. Trans sts to KH, placing all sts behind latches* and with wrong side facing rehang sts from **BACK** hem/**FRONT** hem/**SLEEVE** cuff edge, into hooks of same Ns. Draw one set of sts through the other and using 1 end of D using backstitch, cast off loosely. Remove WY and press **LIGHTLY** to same width as garment piece. **Neckband:** Rep from * to * over 95 sts. With wrong side



facing pick up sts from around neck edge and place into hooks of same Ns. Draw one set of sts through the other and using 1 end of D using backstitch, cast off loosely. **Collar:** Using 2 ends of D cast on 95 sts as FNR, beg with T4/4 and dec tension by $\frac{1}{3}$ every 5 rows, working to RC40. Trans to KH and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join second shoulder as first. Join neckband seam, fold to inside and slipstitch into position. Attach collar to inside neck edge. With right side facing return top of **SLEEVE** sts to Ns. With wrong side facing pick up sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and using either A, B or C using backstitch, cast off loosely.

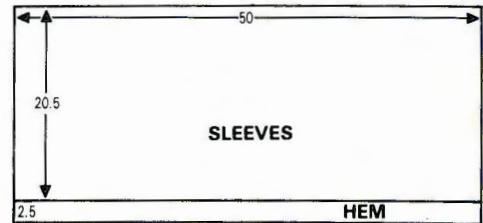
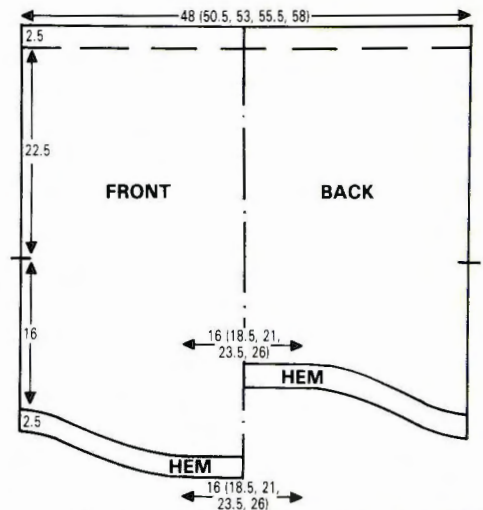


LACE TOP AND DUSTER COAT

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** PINGOUIN Corrida 3; M-800 (850, 900, 950, 1000)g (fuschia 313) (60% cotton 40% acrylic, 420m/100g). Small amounts of fabric in different colours. **VILENE** Bondaweb 4m x 44cm. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Lace - 40 sts = 16.1 cm and 60 rows = 15.4 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T3/3. **NOTES:** It is important that you follow the arrows on the lace card closely. Iron Bondaweb onto fabric for appliqué. Trace shape onto paper of Bondaweb 5 shapes one way, 5 shapes reversed. Cut around traced shape. Peel off paper from back of Bondaweb. Place shape onto garment adhesive side down. Cover with a damp pressing cloth and press with a warm iron. This will bond appliqué to garment. For extra strength and neatness finish with satin stitch around edges.

TOP FRONT

Insert card and lock on row 1. *COR, using M COBH 121 (127, 133, 139, 145) sts. T6 knit 10 rows. T10 knit 1 row, T6 knit 10 rows, COL. T7 knit 1 row, 000*. Waste knit 40 sts at each end of work. Release card and working in lace throughout, and **AT THE SAME TIME** at each end of work, on RC2 and every foll alt row replace 6 inside sts back onto their Ns x 2, 4 inside sts x 3, 2 inside sts x 4 [RC20], 000. Knit 2 rows, replace rem 8 sts each end of work back onto their Ns. **Knit to RC62. Place a WY marker at each



end of work. Knit to RC150. Trans to rib and knit 24 rows. Cast off loosely.**

BACK

Lock card on row 39. Rep from * to * as **FRONT**. Waste knit 40 sts each side of work. Waste knit rem sts. **COR.** At right, replace 8 sts back onto their Ns. Release card and work in lace, and **AT THE SAME TIME** at RC2 and every foll alt row, working from right to left, replace 2 sts x 4, 4 sts x 3, 6 sts x 2. Waste knit. Work left side to match reversing shapings but do not waste knit. Replace all rem sts back onto their Ns. Rep from ** to ** as **FRONT**.

SLEEVES

Block and press **BACK** and **FRONT**. Fold ribbing in half to inside and stitch into position. Join shoulder seams leaving neck opening to required width. Using M, COBH 125 sts. Rep from * to * as **FRONT**. Release card and work in lace to RC80. Waste knit, turn work and replace sts back onto Ns. With wrong side facing, pick up 125 sts evenly along armhole edge between WY markers. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

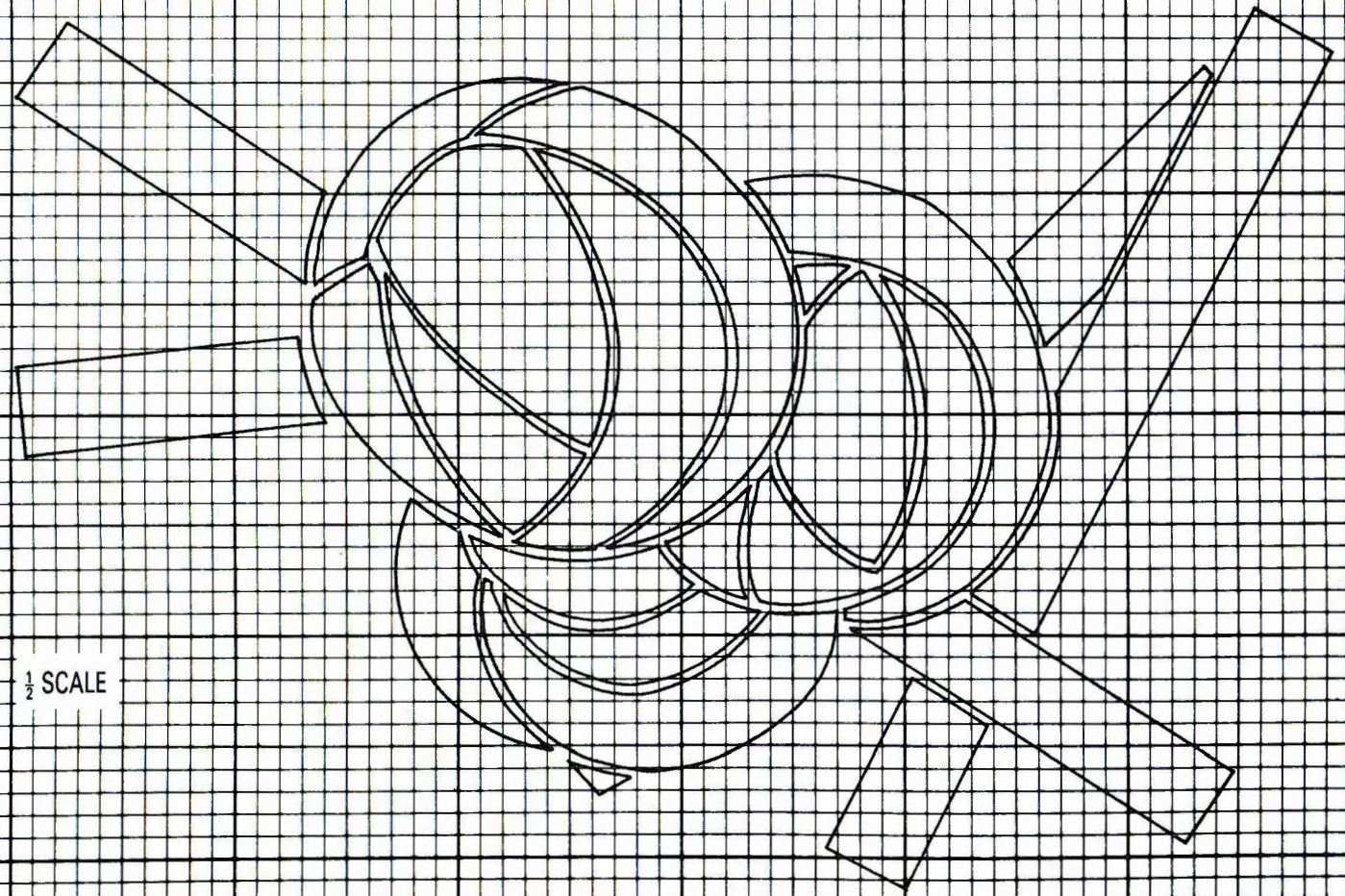
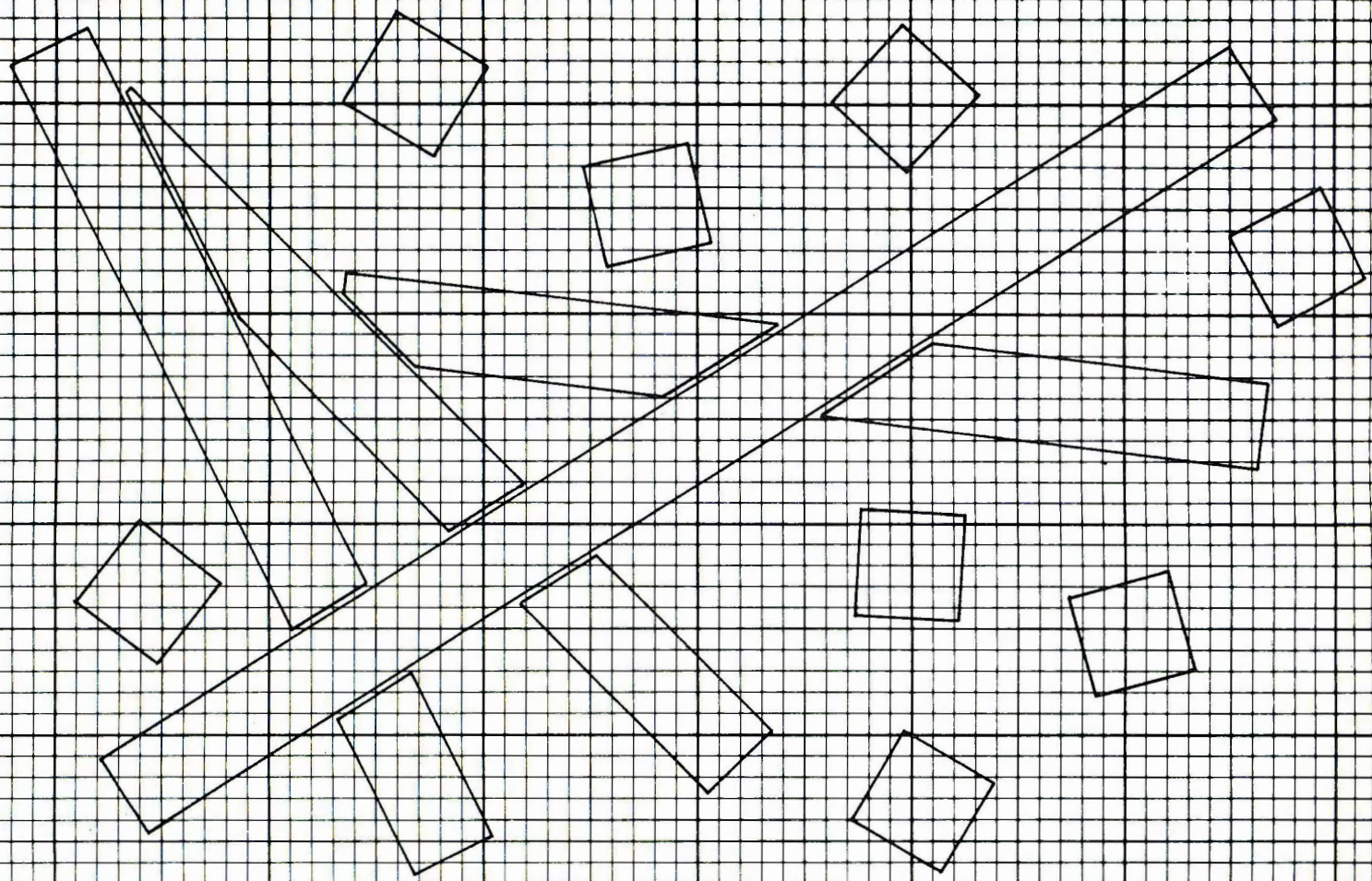

(100% cotton 410m/100g). Elastic to fit waist + 2.5 cm, 18 x 1 cm buttons. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Cardigan: lace and stripe patt - 40 sts = 15.8 cm and 60 rows = 16.6 cm (approx T8 for stripe and T7 for lace). Skirt: st st - 40 sts = 15.3 cm and 60 rows = 16.6 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T2/2 (for cast on edge: knit 1 row, insert comb, knit 2 circular rows only, then set for main rib). **NOTES:** Stripe sequence: *4 rows M, 2 rows A, 4 rows M, 2 rows B*, rep from * to *. Purl side is right side of garment.

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast



on 129 (135, 141, 149, 155) sts as rib (see RIB) and knit 28 rows. COL, trans to KH. Inc 1 st and knit 1 row, COR. Waste knit half the sts to left, 000. Inc 1 st at left edge (for seam allowance). Knit 4 rows. T7 release card and work in lace to RC104, COR, 000. Place a WY marker at right edge of work. Knit 1 row. T8 change to B and knit 2 rows, cont in stripe patt to RC100. Waste knit 39 (42, 45, 49, 52) sts at right for shoulder. Cast off rem 27 sts. Place sts from left side back onto Ns, COL, 000. Inc 1 st at right (for seam allowance). T8 using M knit 2 rows, cont in stripe patt to RC104, COL, 000. Place a WY marker at left edge of work. Set card to row 1. T7 release card and cont in lace to RC100. Waste knit 39 (42, 45, 49, 52) sts at left for shoulder. Cast off rem 27 sts. Mattress stitch centre back seam.

RIGHT FRONT

Neck shaping

COL. *At beg of next and alt rows cast off 8 (9, 8, 8, 9) sts x 1, 4 sts x 1, 3 sts x 1, 2 sts x 2, 1 st x 5. Knit to RC108 and waste knit rem 39 (42, 45, 49, 52) sts.*

LEFT FRONT

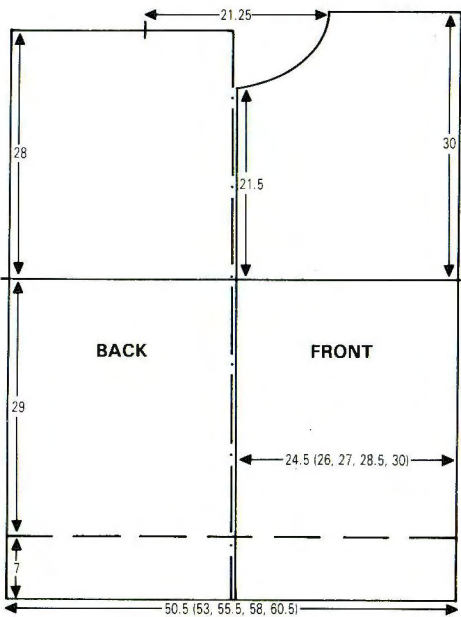
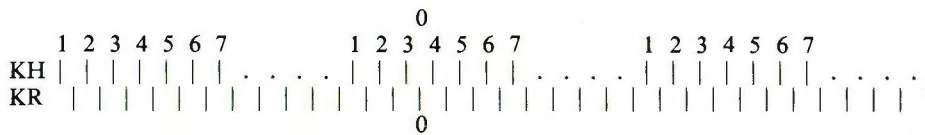

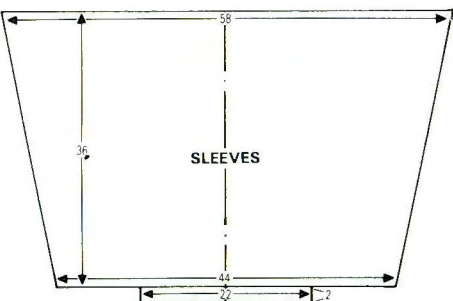

collar only. Attach collar to neck edge by backstitching through last row knitted in A, first on the outside and then on the inside.

MACHINES: A, B or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** SILVERKNIT YARNS Ideal; TOP - M - 300 (325, 350, 375, 400)g (Shade 1703 - yellow), Con Col - 80 (90, 100, 110, 120)g (Shade 1701 - white), DRESS - M 550 (575, 600, 625, 650)g, Con Col - 200 (220, 240, 260, 280)g (100% viscose 500m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Skip/lace/stripe patt - 40 sts = 12.5 cm and 60 rows = 12.8 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 2 \times 2 T1/1. **NOTES:** Using 2 ends of M together and 1 end of Con Col work patt as follows: *Set for skip (both PART buttons depressed) using 2 ends of M, knit 8 rows, set for st st, using 1 end of Con Col, knit 2 rows, operate the L-Carr from left to right and right to left, knit 1 row. Set K-Carr to KC, knit 1 row. Set for skip (both PART buttons depressed), using 2 ends of M, knit 8 rows. Set for st st, using 1 end of Con Col, knit 2 rows, operate the L-Carr from left to right, then right to left, left to right, and finally right to left, knit 1 row. TWILLEYS Goldfingering; A - 50-60 g (GD38) (20% metalised polyester, 80% viscose, 400m/100g). 7 buttons. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Skirt - using 1 end of M, 40 sts = 21 cm and 60 rows = 20 cm (approx T6), bodice - using 3 ends of M together, 40 sts = 14.2 cm and 60 rows = 15.6 cm (approx T6). **NOTES:** Punchcard machines use card 1 from basic pack. C machines use sheet 1 from basic pack. Weave across selected Ns in 'squares' as illustrated (8 sts \times 10 rows) at random, keep skirt hem edge, collar and armhole edges constant.

SKIRT

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using WY cast on 114 sts and knit a few rows. Change to 1 end of M, T6. Set K-Carr to KC, release card and place weaving brushes into WP. 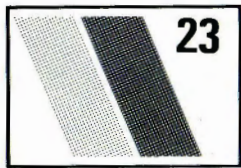
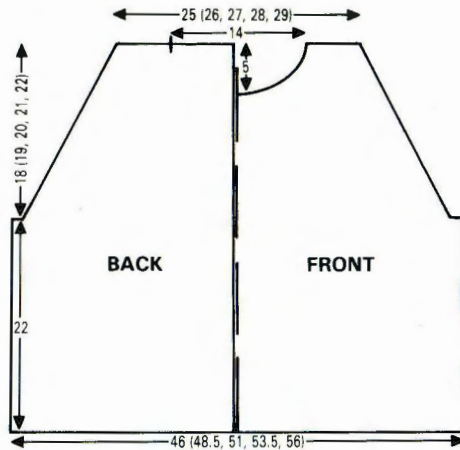

MACHINES: A or C with KR. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive DK; M - 250 (275, 300, 325, 350)g (Black 6194), A - 200 (225, 250, 275, 300)g (Yellow 6211), B - 225 (250, 275, 300, 325)g (Scarlet 6196) (50% acrylic, 25% Nylon, 25% wool, 300m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 81 (86, 91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle - 40 sts = 13.9 cm and 60 rows = 17.7 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 3 x 1 T8/4 (Cast on as 1 x 1 T1/1, knit 2 circular rows, then trans to 3 x 1).

BACK

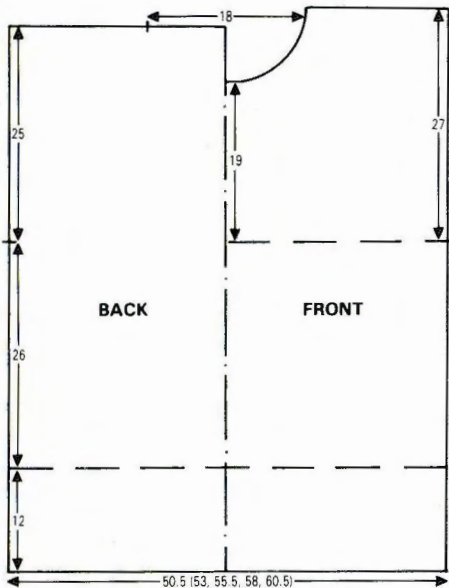
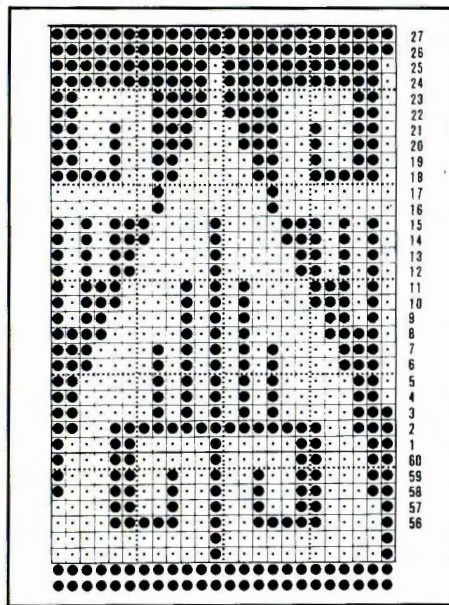

PATSY YARNS Special 4-ply; A - 120 (125, 130, 135, 140)g (Red S13), B - 50 (50, 50, 55, 55)g (Blue S9), C - 50 (50, 50, 55, 55)g (Yellow S14), D - 50 (50, 50, 55, 55)g (Black S12) (100% acrylic, 600m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Woven patt - 20 sts = 12 cm and 30 rows = 10.7 cm (approx T3). **RIB:** Using 2 ends of A together - 1 x 1 T1/1. Slide lever II. **NOTES:** Purl side is right side of fabric. Use 1 end of C and 1 end of B together, also 1 end of A and 1 end of D together as weaving yarns. Insert card and lock on row 1, COL. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row. Place Weaving Brushes into WP. Release card*. **Push selected Ns to HP. Working from left to right, wind anti-clockwise 1 end of C and B together around selected Ns. Knit 1 row, COL. Push selected Ns to HP. Working from right to left, wind clockwise 1 end of C and B together around selected Ns.** Rep from ** to **, using A and D instead of C and B. Knit 4 rows.* Rep from * to * throughout.



Pitch Lever to H. **NOTES:** Weaving stripe sequence: with M in FA throughout, *weave 12 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B, 2 rows with A, 2 rows with B*. Rep from * to * throughout. Lock card on row 1 throughout.

Using M and KG-88 cast on 142 (150, 158, 166, 174) sts as rib and knit 12 rows, 000. Change to card illustrated T6 and knit to RC106. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Knit to RC186 (190, 194, 198, 202).

Neck shaping

Change to K-Carr. Waste knit centre 40 sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Change to KG-88 and knit 1 row. At beg of next and every foll alt row cast off 6 sts × 1, 4 sts × 1, 3 sts × 2, 2 sts × 2, 1 st × 3, AT THE SAME TIME at RC204 (208, 212, 216, 220) ...

Shape shoulder

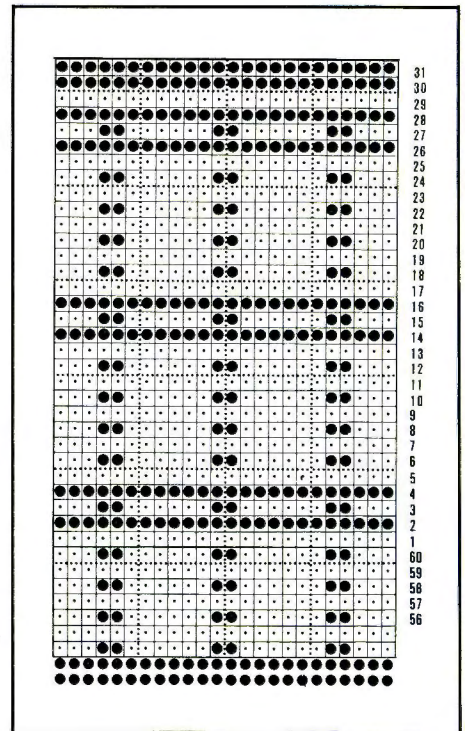

CARD B - with M in FA and A in FB throughout.

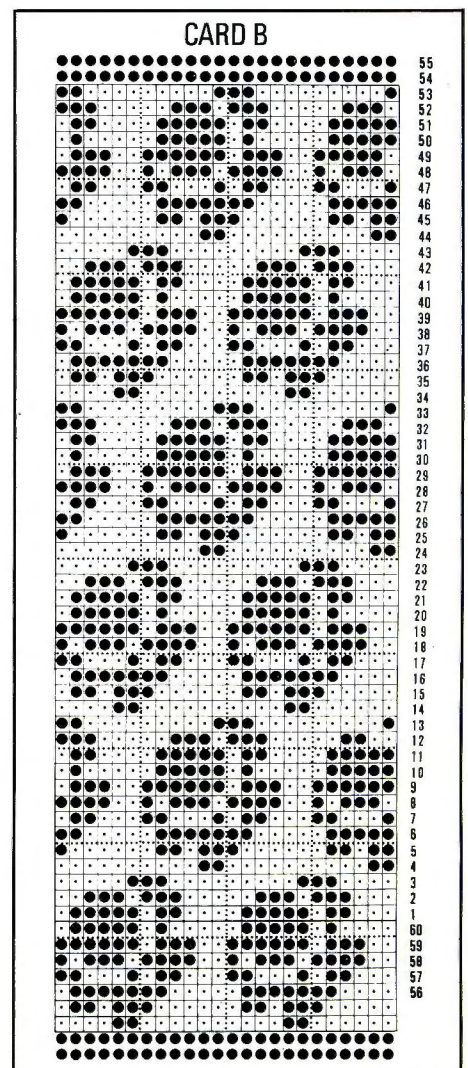

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 152 (160, 168, 176, 184) sts as rib and knit to RC100, 000. Trans to KH. Release card and work in fairisle (see NOTES) to RC110.

Lace (Chart II), 20 sts = 17.3 cm and 30 rows = 13.6 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** Cast on with every 3rd N in NWP, T6, knit required number of rows, push empty

Ns to WP and latch up horizontal loops to form purl sts, place last st onto empty N. Count Ns in NWP as sts. **NOTES:** FRONT-Work intarsia "squares" 10 sts wide and 15 rows deep 4 (4, 4, 5, 5, 6) sts from edge of work. For lace "squares" foll Chart I. **SLEEVES:** Foll Chart II, ensure that sts are not trans for lace patt at edge of work.

BACK

Using A COBH 46 (50, 50, 52) sts, rep from * to * as BACK / FRONT PANELS. Knit to RC212 (230, 248, 276). Rep from ** to ** over centre 24 (28, 28, 30) Ns. Knit 4 rows, 000.



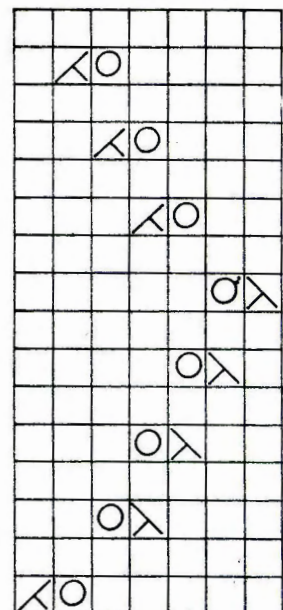

Fairisle - 40 sts = 13.5 cm and 60 rows = 17 cm (approx T8). **RIB:** Collar and cuffs: 3 x 1 T5/2 (Cast on as 1 x 1 rib, knit 2 circular rows and then trans for 3 x 1 working from centre outwards); Waist ribs: 2 x 2 T3/3 Pitch H. **NOTES:** Divide intarsia 'squares'



as diagram; if you are not using the KL the centre 'square' is 53 (55, 57, 59, 61) sts wide. All 'squares' have 66 rows. Intarsia "squares" worked in A - trans every 4th st to adjacent N and push empty Ns to NWP, work "square" then return Ns to WP.

BACK

Knit to RC112. Waste knit centre 53 (55, 57, 59, 61) sts. Waste knit rem 53 (55, 58, 60, 63) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

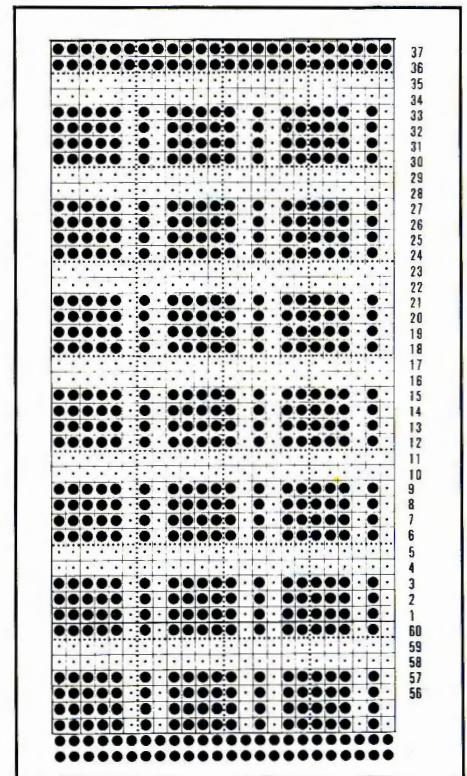

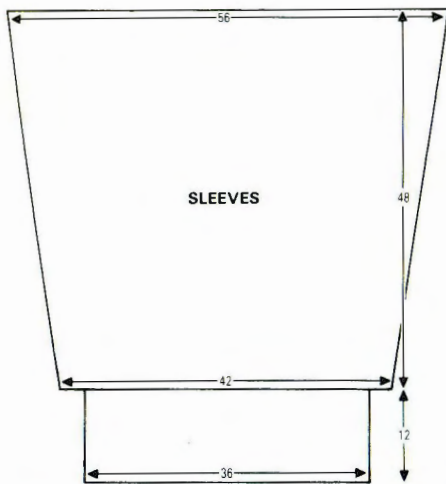

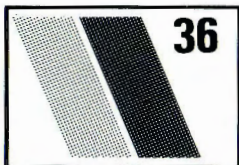

TWILLEYS Goldfingering; C - 20 g (20% metalised polyester, 80% viscose, 500m/100g). **MEASUREMENTS:** Height - 120 (130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 40 sts = 13.4 cm and 60 rows = 14.2 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T2/2.

BACK

Using A cast on 111 (117, 123, 131) sts as RIB and knit 26 rows. Trans to KH, 000*. Change to M T7 knit 96 (100, 110, 118) rows. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC60 (64, 68, 72). Waste knit centre 43 (43, 45, 45) sts. Waste knit rem 34 (37, 39, 43) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

As BACK working intarsia from Chart from *. Work to RC38 (42, 46, 50) above WY markers.

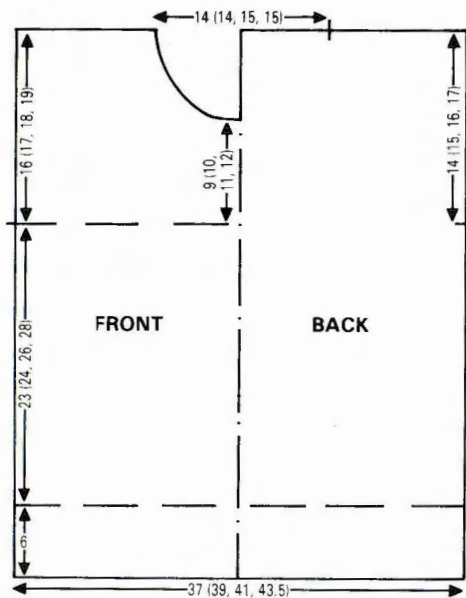
Neck shaping

Waste knit centre 11 (11, 13, 13) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and every foll alt row cast off 3 sts \times 2, 2

sts \times 1, then dec 1 st \times 6. Knit to RC68 (72, 76, 80) and waste knit. Return sts at left back onto Ns and knit to match right side reversing shapings.

Neckband

Join one shoulder by placing one set of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. With right side facing pick up 101 (101, 105, 105) sts evenly along neck edge. Using B, T7 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, knit 24 rows. Trans to KH, T7 knit 2 rows, waste knit.

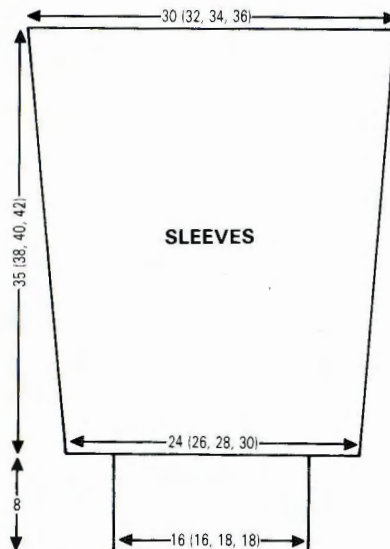


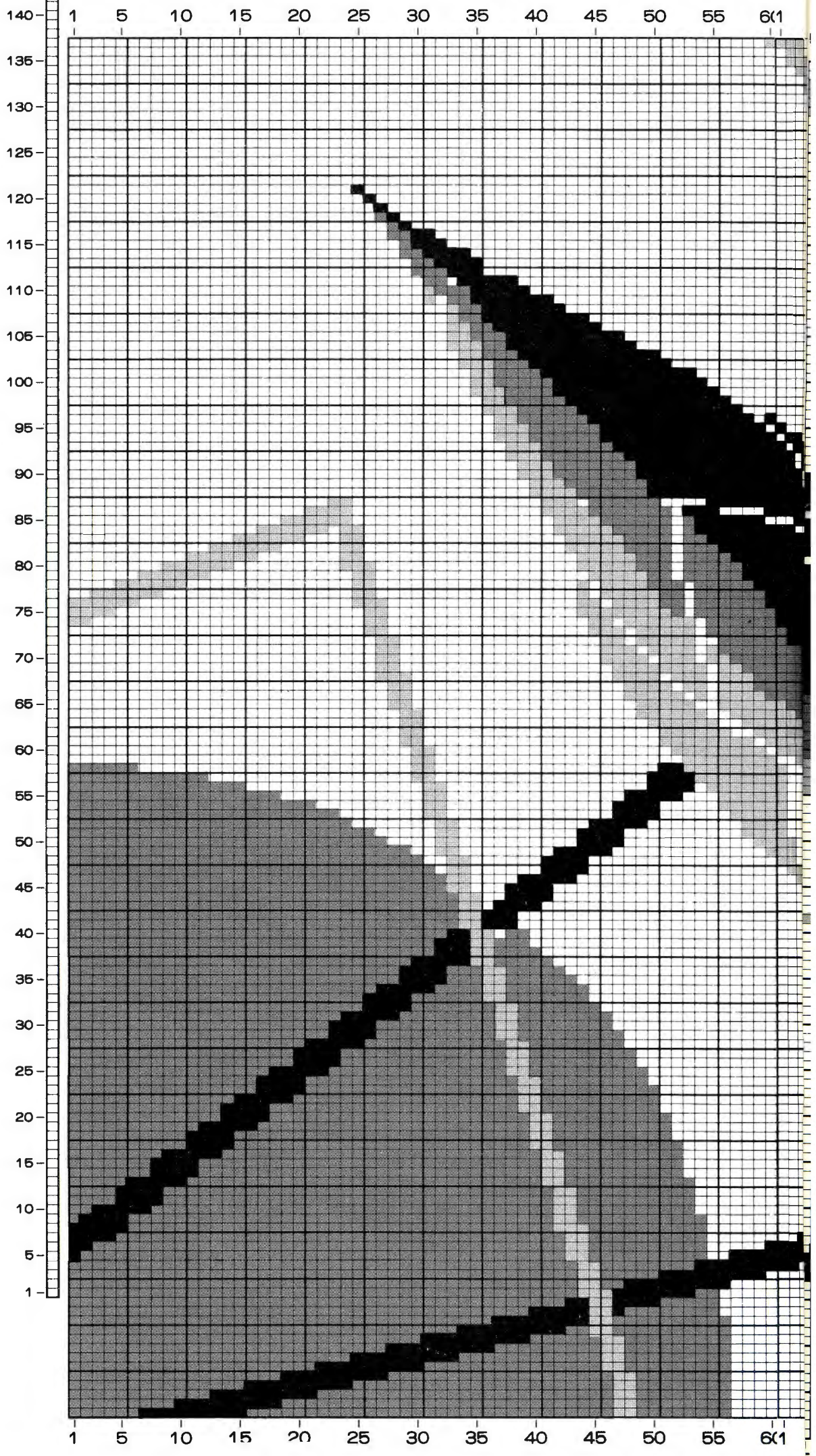
SLEEVES

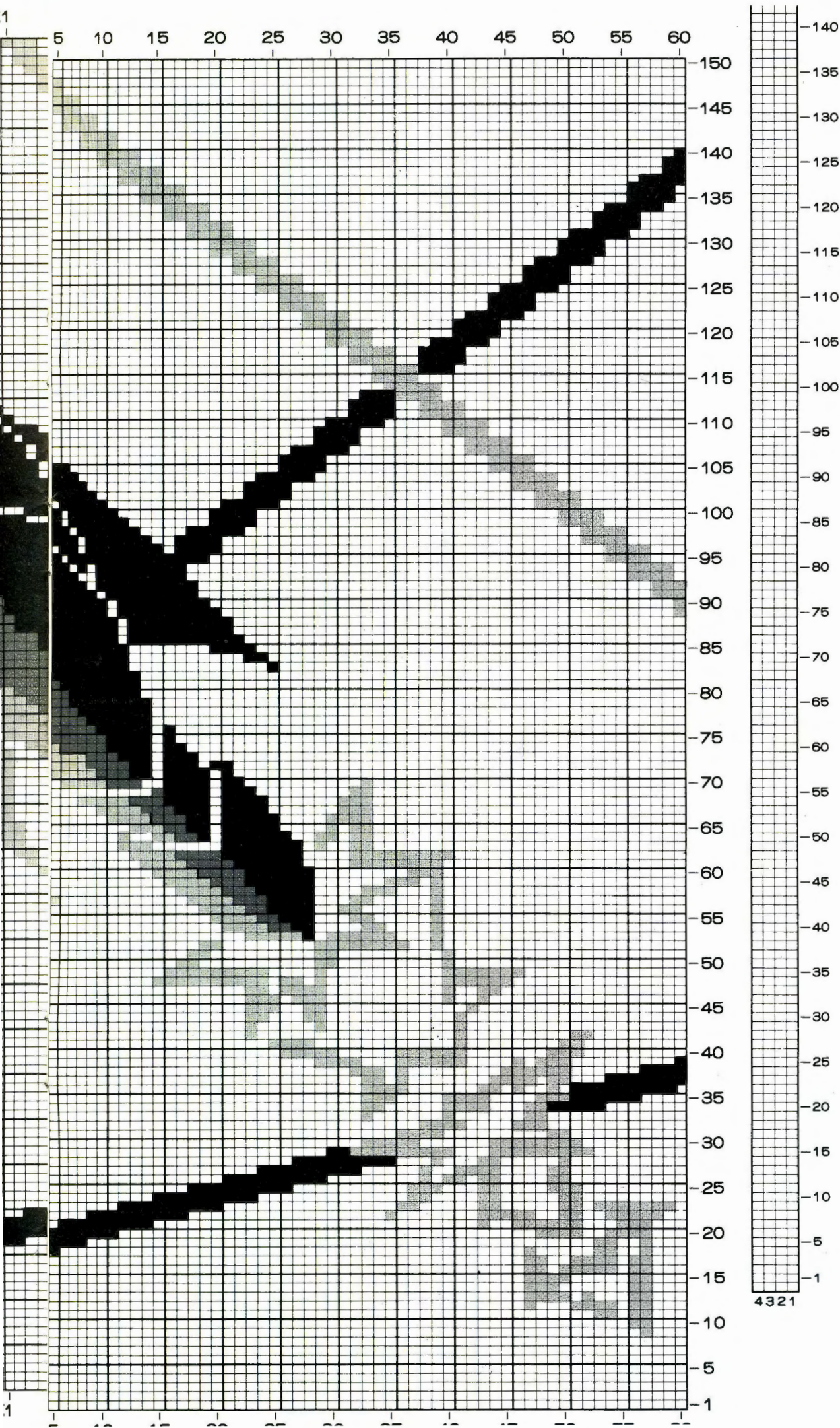
Join second shoulder as first. With wrong side facing pick up 90 (96, 102, 108) sts evenly along armhole edge between markers, 000. T7 using M knit to RC2 (16, 24, 32). Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 16th row \times 9. Knit to RC148 (160, 168, 176) waste knit but DO NOT BREAK YARN. *Cuffs:* Push 49 (49, 55, 55) Ns into WP. Replace sts from cuff edge back onto Ns distributing sts evenly along the row. T7 knit 1 row. Trans to rib, knit 36 rows. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

MAKE-UP

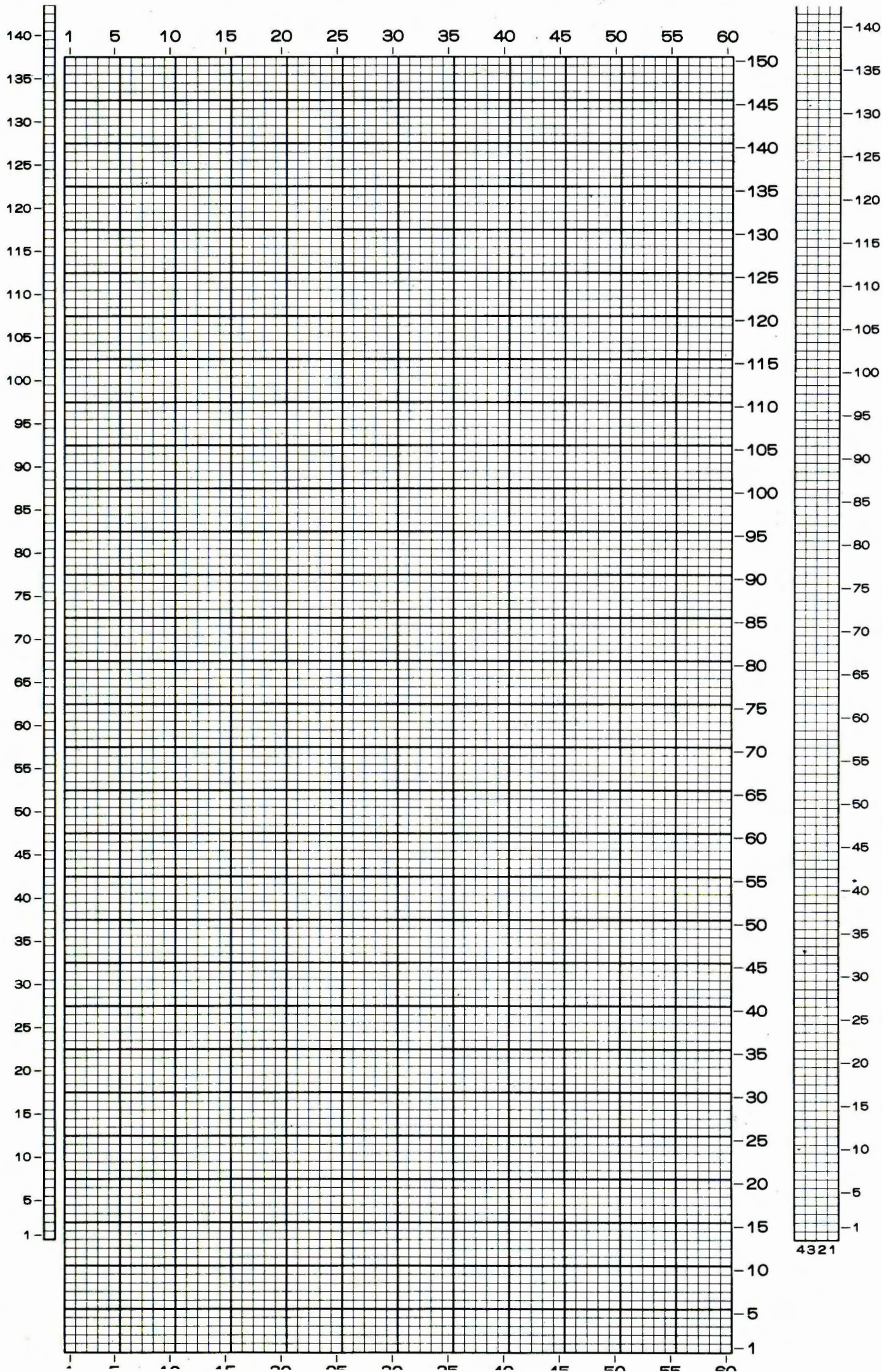
Block and press lightly. Join side, sleeve and neckband seams. Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in B.



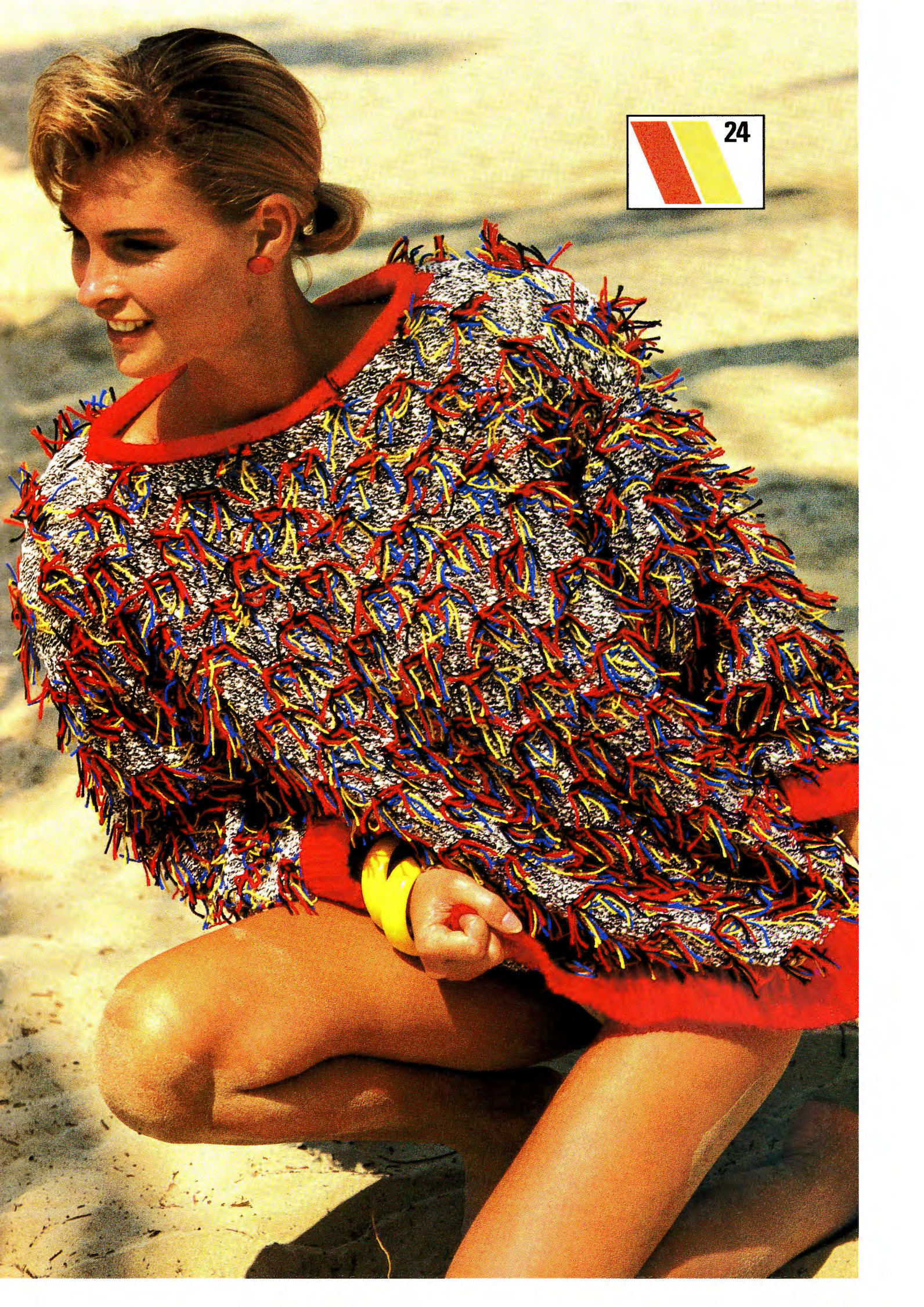




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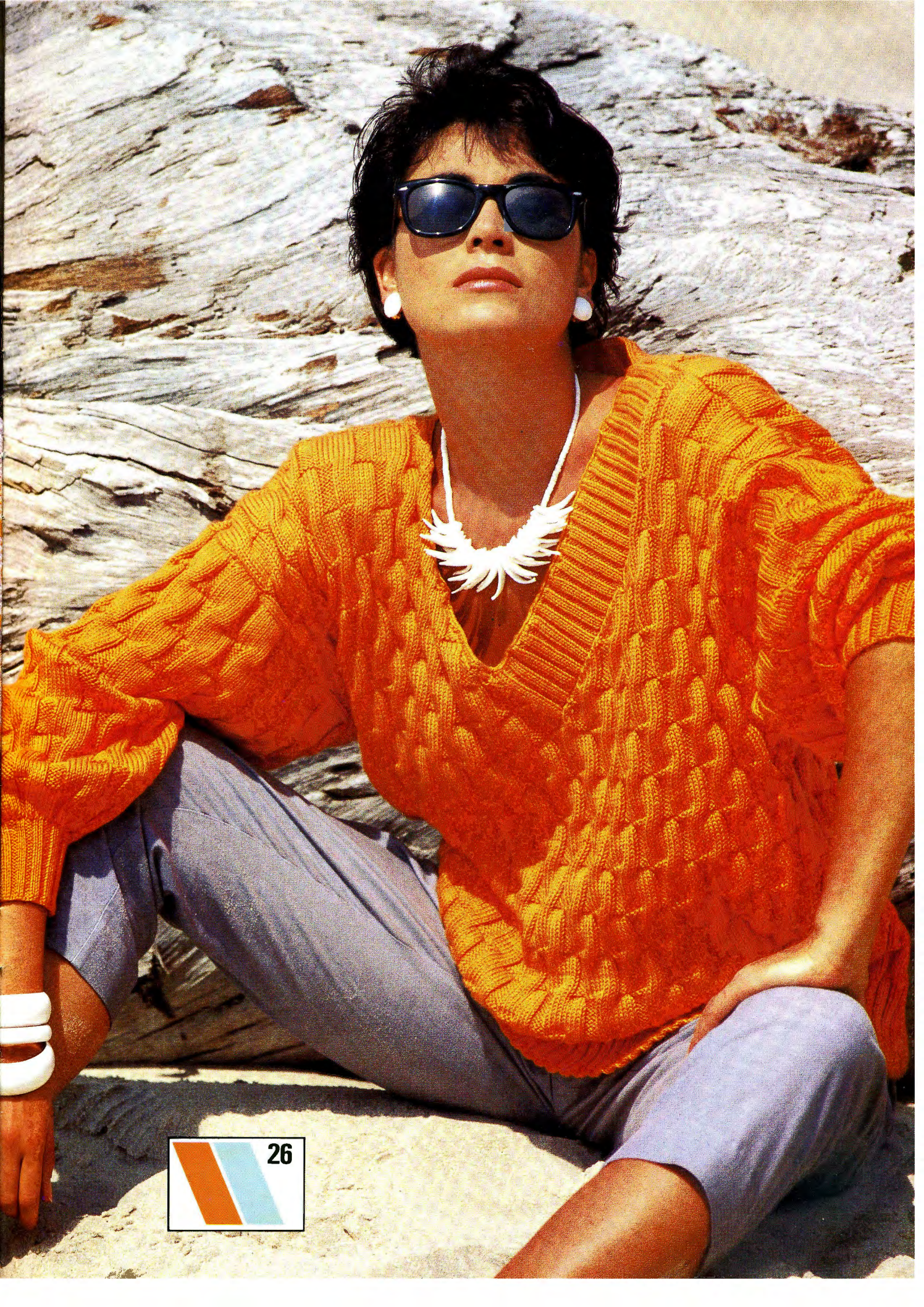


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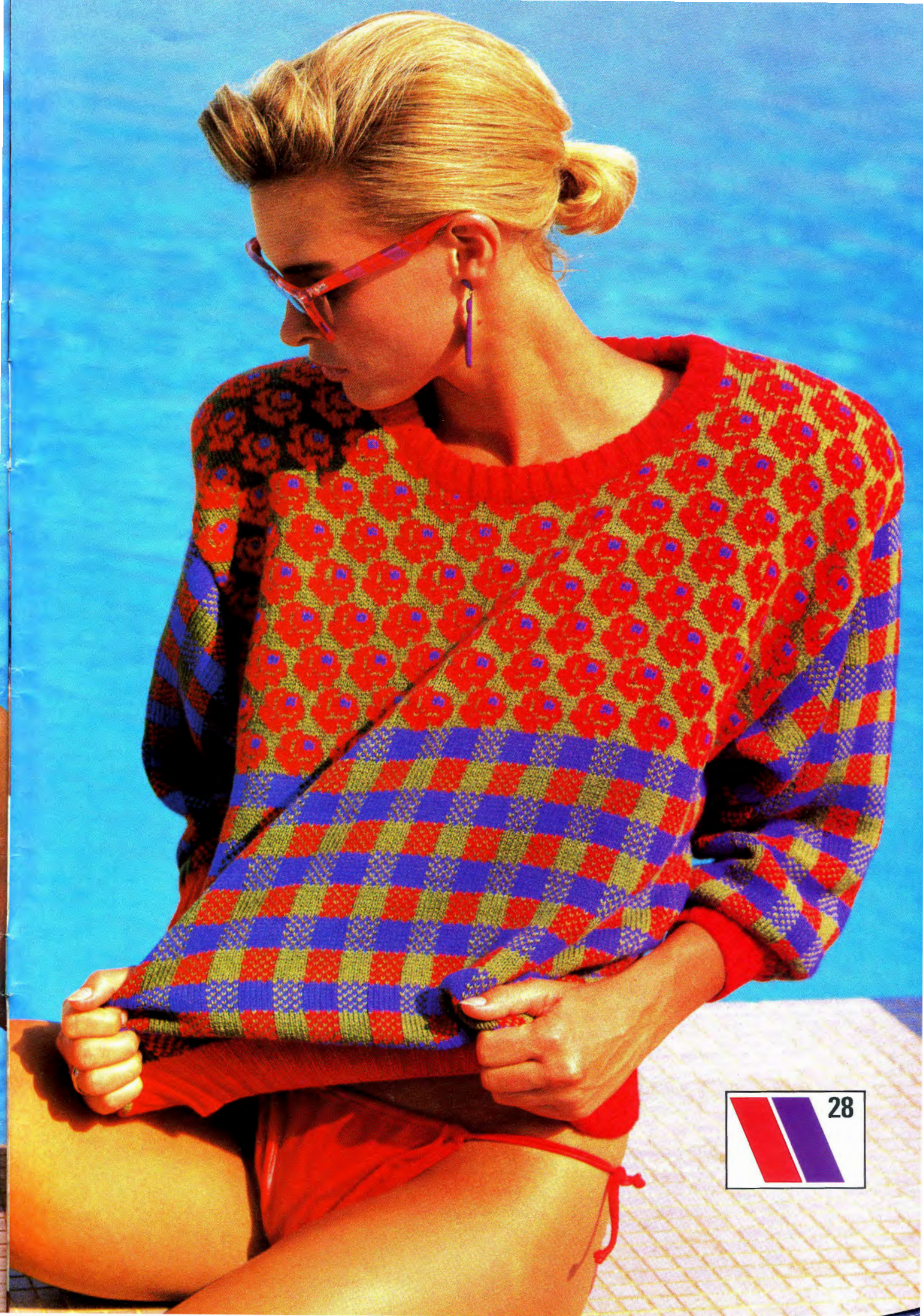


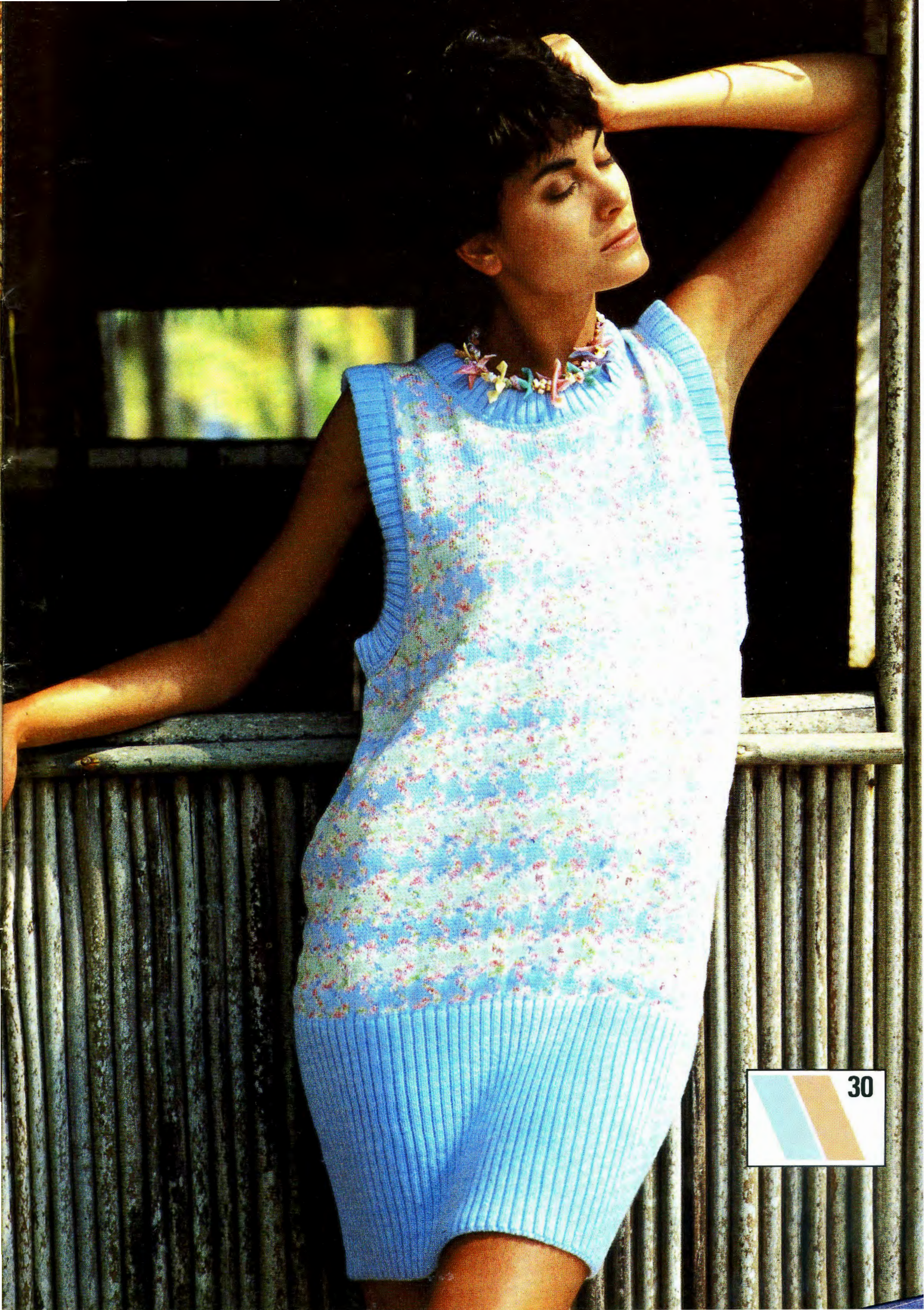


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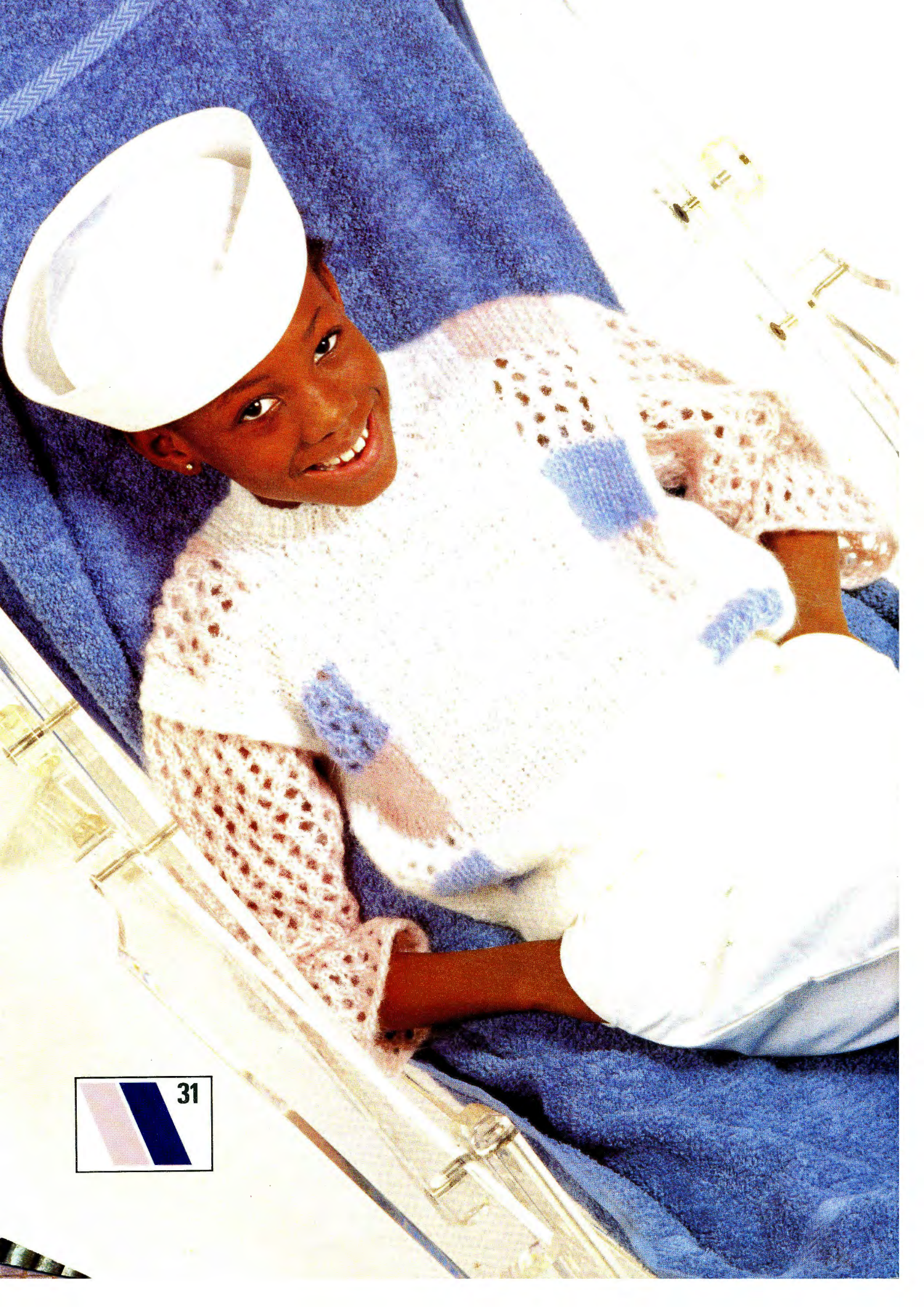








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
