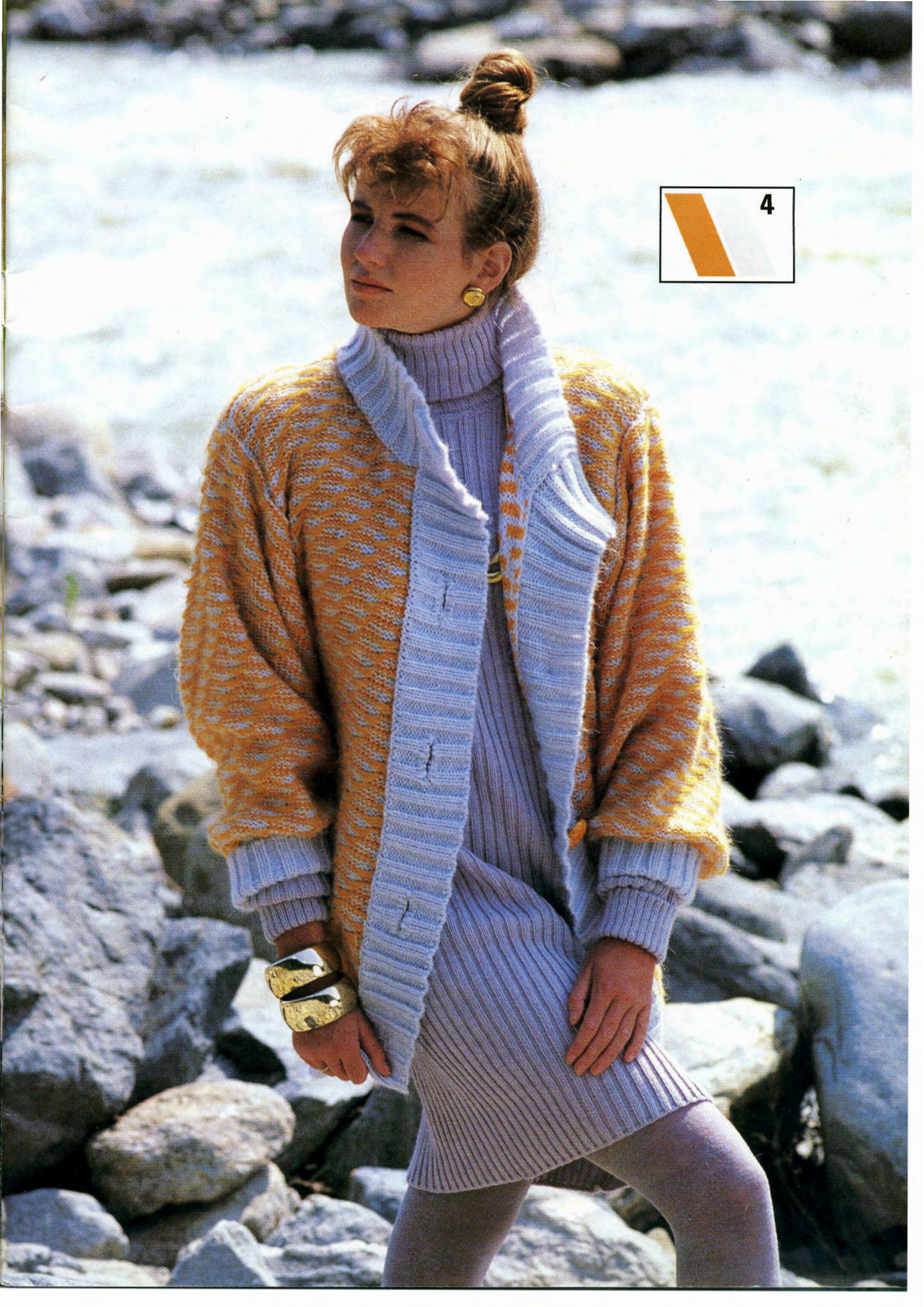


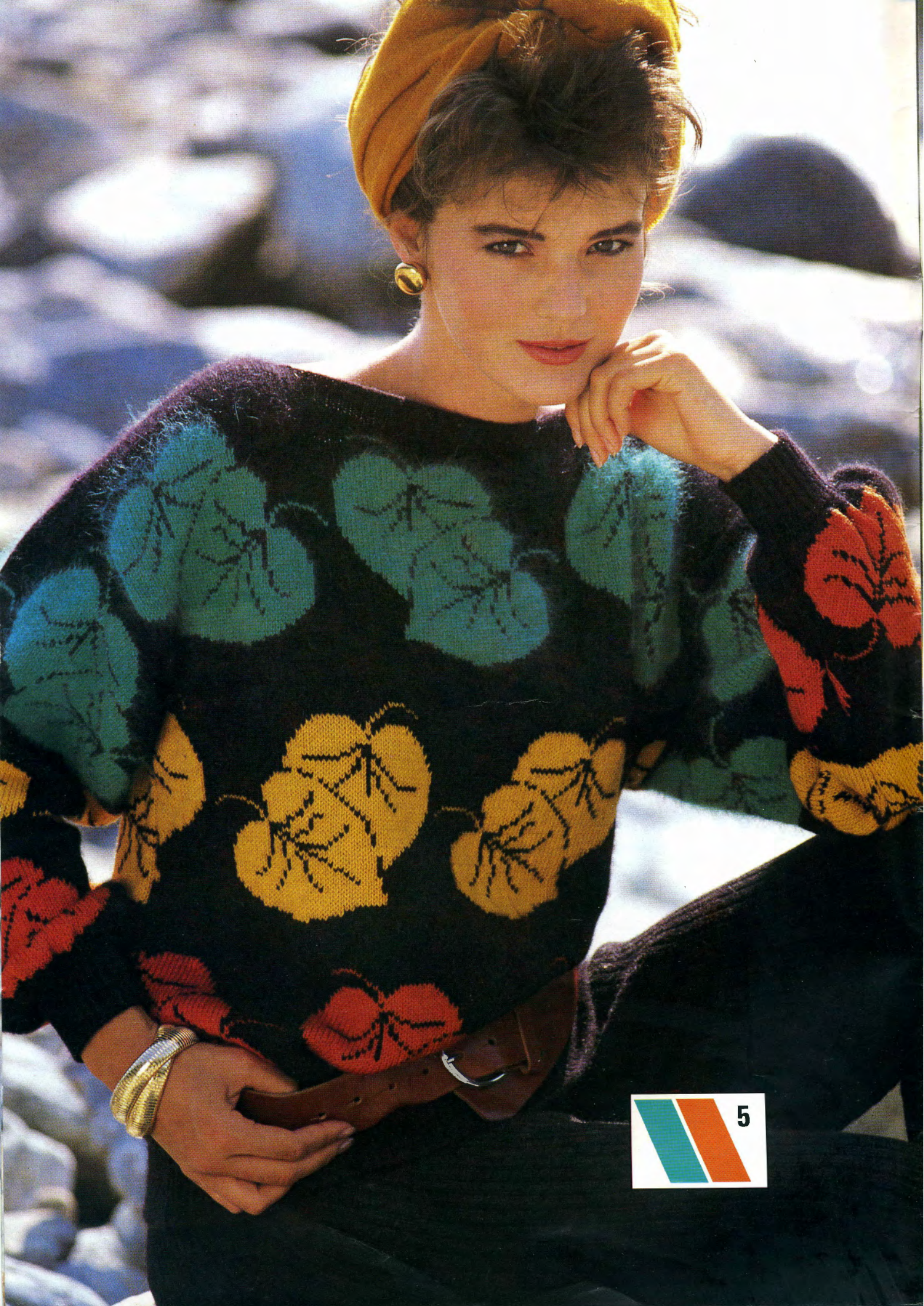
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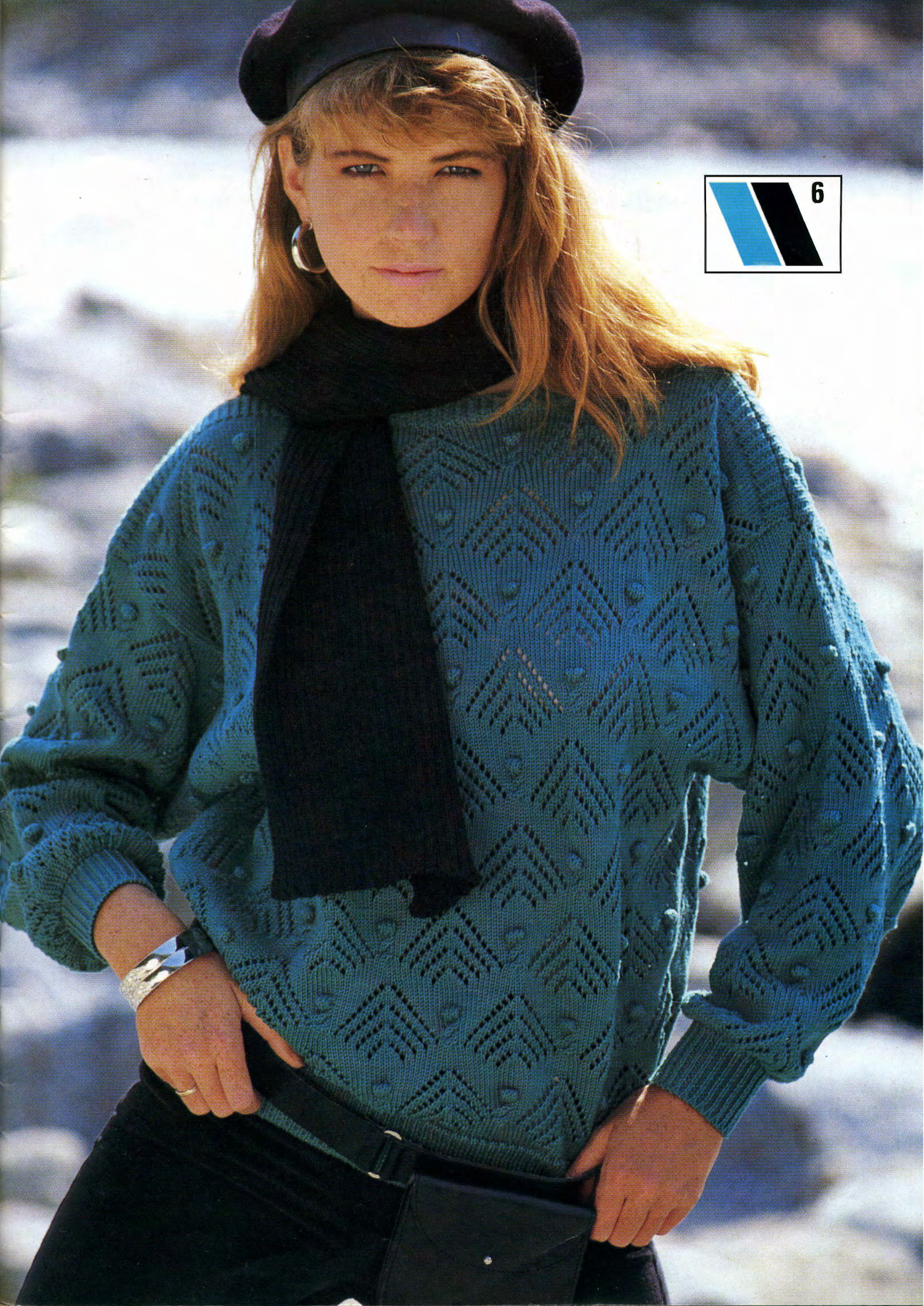




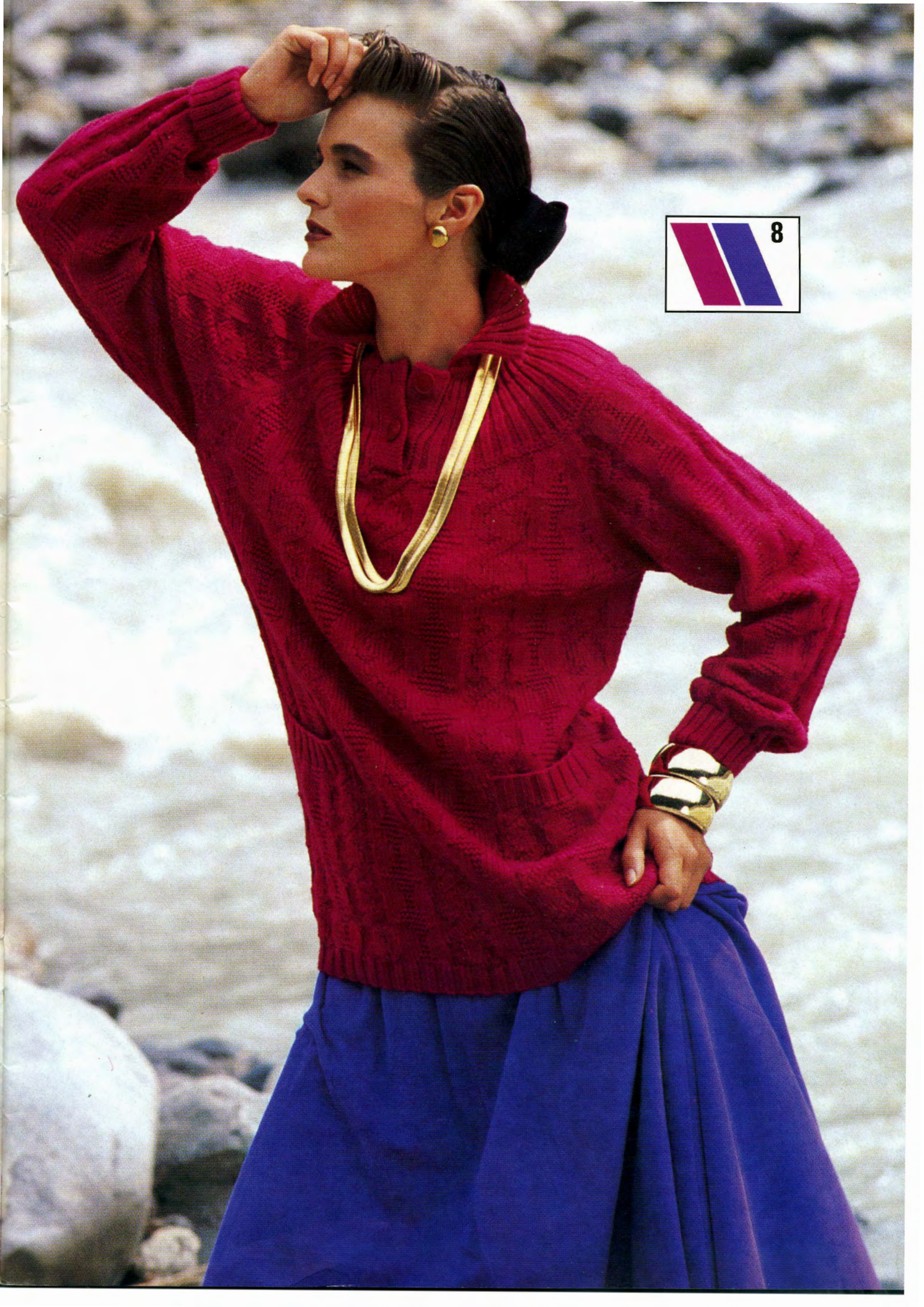




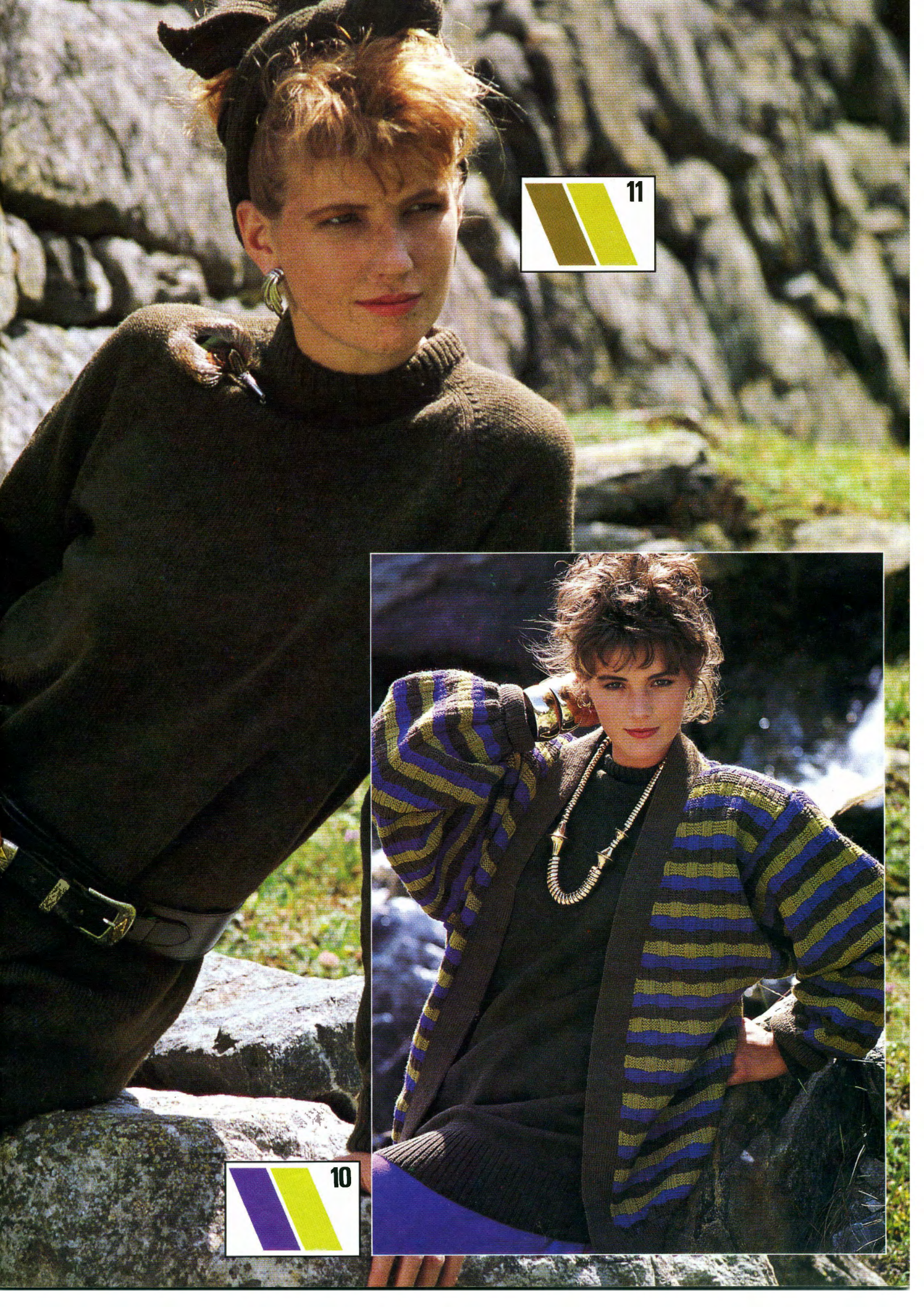


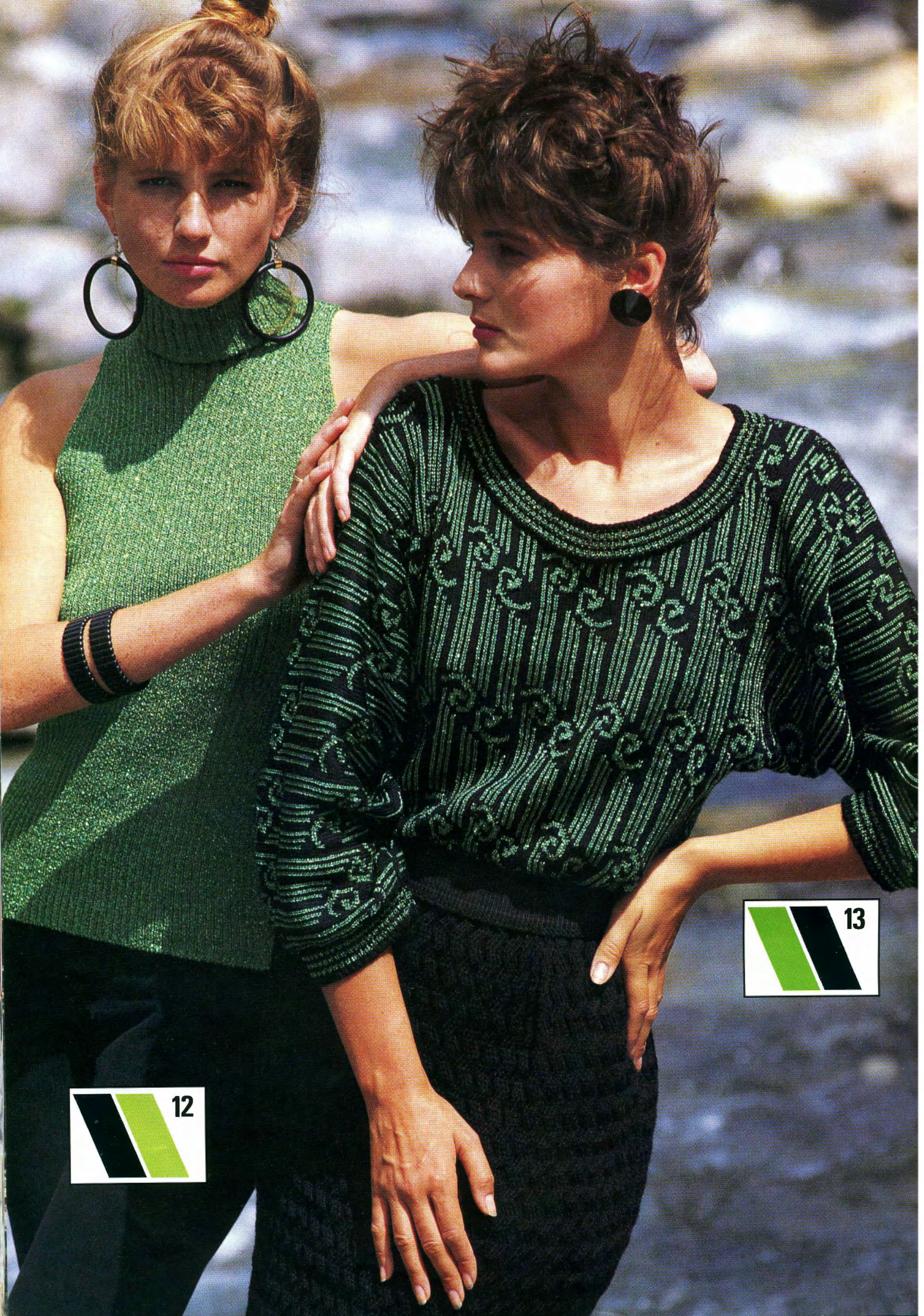














A cool classic winter

After the rather brash, bright colours of summer, the softer, subtle and classic colours of winter are a welcome change. Tangerine gives way to golds and rusts, cerise to raspberry, and turquoise to softer blues and greys. Jewel colours—ruby, gold, purple, jade and emerald—emulate a feeling of luxury, set against pewter, bronze and peat, and of course no fashion story is complete without black and white.

Our winter collection consists of a range of coordinated garments. Wear the sweaters or tops with leggings, the dresses with jackets or cardigans, and complete the outfit with balaklava and a hat or two—be warm and fashionable.

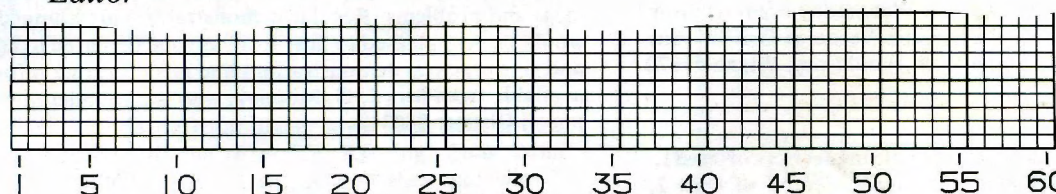
Garment shapes are on the move. The drop shoulder is receiving competition from the ever popular raglan sleeve which fits so well. Now's the time to work on those fully-fashioned increases and decreases which give a professional finish to knitwear. Favoured design details include the yoke and polo collars set into wide, deep necklines, and, speaking of favourites, we have included some of the traditional lace and fairisle stitch designs—beautiful in earth or jewel colours.

Select a garment shape and use it for standard and bulky machines, for casual or formal wear. Once you have found the best garment shape for you, whichever machine you have, it is the colour, yarn and stitch choice that gives garments that certain individuality which machine knitters discover over and over again. Three of our designs worked on the bulky machine show you how to overcome the situation of the garment shape being larger than the Knitleader sheet. Still without a Knitleader? Treat yourself. When working intarsia designs in particular, on both standard and bulky machines, the Knitleader is invaluable.

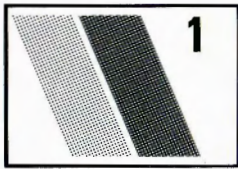

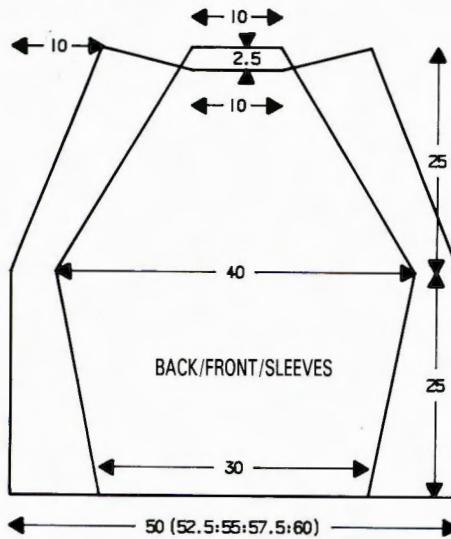


LADY'S INTARSIA SWEATER

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G (machines which do not have intarsia facility use Intarsia Carriage) with KR and KL. **MATERIALS:** LAINES ANNY BLATT Angor'anny; M - 240 (250, 260, 270, 280) g (Shade 550), A - 80 (90, 100, 110, 120) g (Shade 642), B - 140 (150, 160, 170, 180) g (Shade 1740) (70% angora, 30% wool, 475 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** St st/Intarsia (when making your tension swatch use Intarsia Carriage if you intend to work the garment with the Intarsia Carriage - Intarsia Carriage and K-Carr tensions can be very different) - 40 sts = 16.2 cm and 60 rows = 19 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 2 x 1 N arrangement on both KH and KR. Pitch to H T5/5.

PROCEDURE

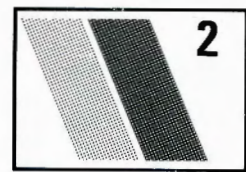
Make a tension swatch and set KL accordingly. Draw the garment shape in size required onto the KL sheet. Draw Intarsia design onto KL sheet. **Waist ribs:** Using M cast on required No of sts as RIB and knit



40 rows. Trans to KH and cont in Intarsia Patt. **Cuffs:** Using M cast on the required No of sts as RIB, knit 20 rows then cont in Intarsia patt. **Collar:** Join 3 raglan seams leaving one back seam open. Using B cast on required No of sts as RIB, T7/7 knit 10 rows, T6/6 knit 10 rows, T5/5 knit 4 rows, T4/4 knit 8 rows, T5/5 knit 4 rows, T6/6 knit 10 rows, T7/7 knit 10 rows. Pick up sts evenly along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off.

MAKE-UP

Join raglan and neckband seam. Join side and sleeve seams.

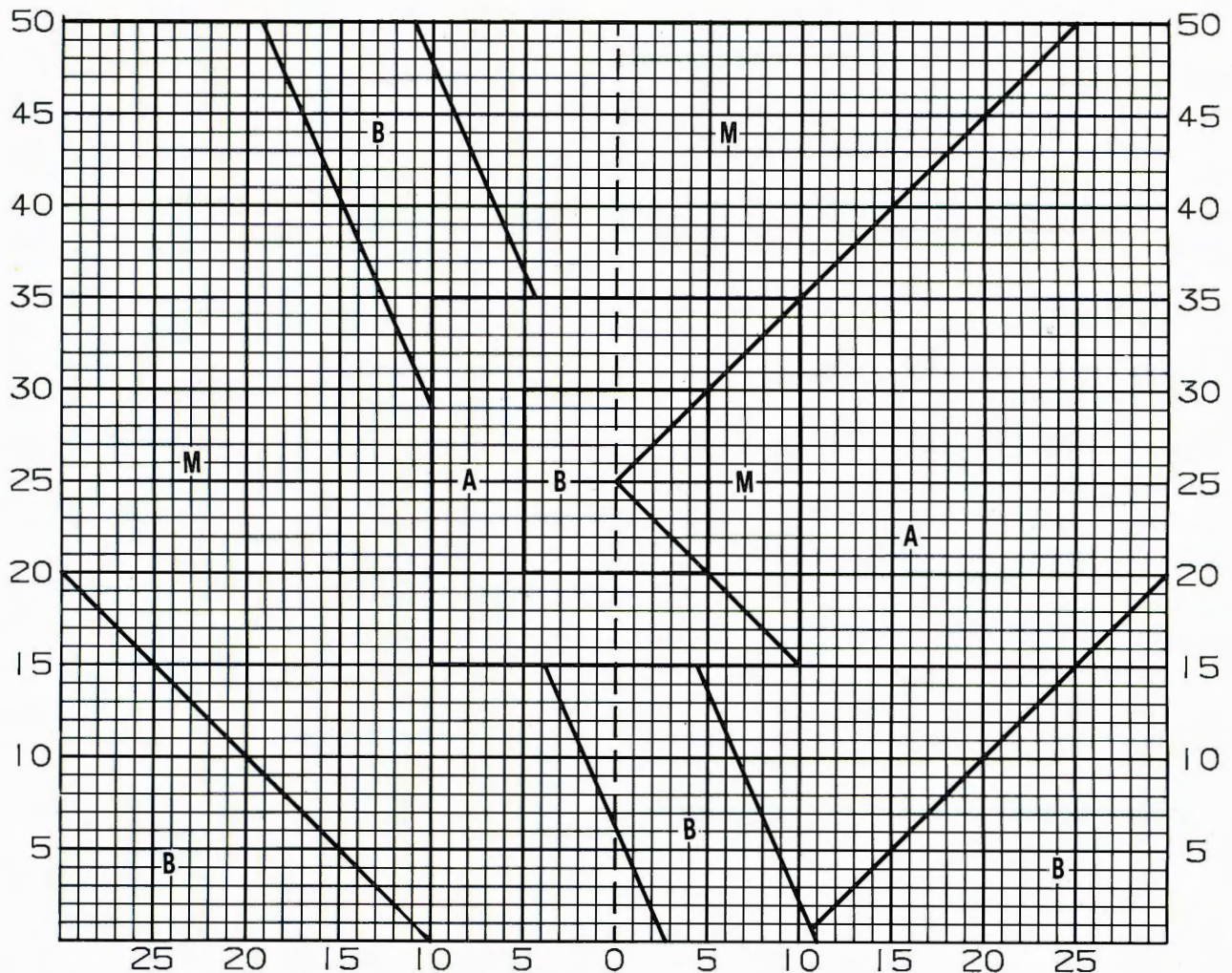


TUCK STITCH SWEATER

MACHINES: E with KR. **MATERIALS:** ARGYLL WOOLS Fluffy One DK; M - 375 (385, 395, 405, 415) g (White 315), Con Col - 75 (85, 95, 105, 115) g (Black 344), (80% acrylic, 20% nylon, 300 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Tuck st - 20 sts = 19 cm and 30 rows = 7.5 cm (approx T5). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T1/1 Slide Lever II. **NOTES:** Use Card 1 from basic KH-260 set with Card Lock Lever set to ∇ (double length) throughout. To make decorative crosses, work strips in M and Con Col as follows: Using WY T5 cast on 10 sts and knit a few rows. Change to M or Con Col and knit 30 rows. Waste knit. To attach strips graft through first and last row knitted in M or Con Col.

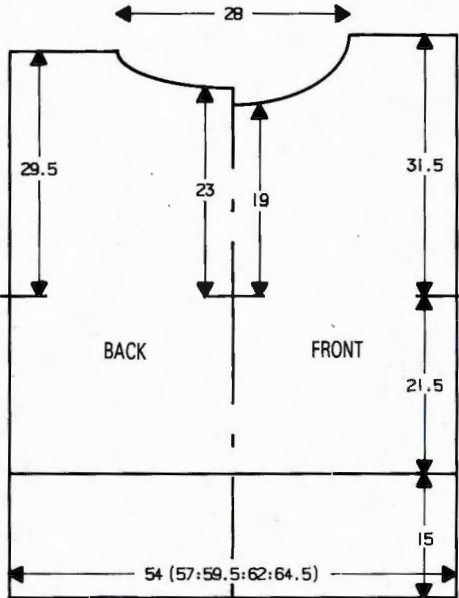
BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 57 (59, 63, 65, 67) sts as RIB and knit 38 rows. Trans to KH. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns, 000. T5 release card and work in tuck patt to RC86. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC92.



Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Waste knit centre 13 sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. *Knit 2 rows, using the Nylon Cast-on Cord, take 1 inside N back to NWP*. Rep from * to * × 6. Knit 4 rows, using the Nylon Cast-on Cord take 1 inside N back to NWP × 2 [14 (15, 17, 18, 19) sts rem]. Knit to RC118 and waste knit. Waste knit sts on Cast-on Cord. Return sts at left to Ns, reset card and RC. Knit to match right side reversing shapings.



FRONT

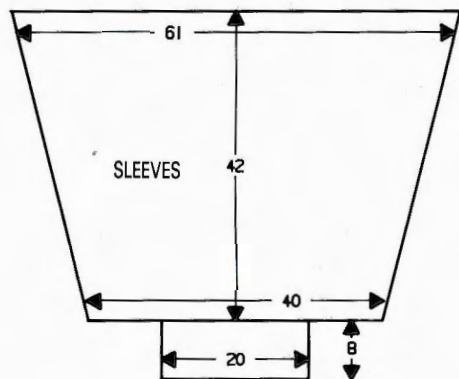
As BACK to RC76 above WY markers.

Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Waste knit centre 11 sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Rep from * to * as BACK × 6. Knit 4 rows, using the Nylon Cast-on Cord, take 1 inside N back to NWP × 1, knit 6 rows, using the Nylon Cast-on Cord, take 1 inside N back to NWP × 2. [14 (15, 17, 18, 19) sts rem] Knit to RC126 and waste knit. Waste knit sts on Cast-on Cord. Return sts at left to Ns, reset card and RC. Knit to match reversing shapings.

COLLAR

Join one shoulder seam by placing one set of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. Using M T10 knit 1 row and latch off. Using WY cast on 93 sts and knit a few rows, T5 change to Con Col and knit 2 rows. Pick up same number of sts from around collar edge of BACK and FRONT including sts on WY, and hang them onto Ns. Using M T10 knit 1 row. Trans to 1 × 1 RIB, 000.



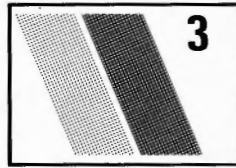
T1/1 knit to RC100, T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off. Backstitch through first row knitted in Con Col around base of collar. Join second shoulder seam. Join collar seam.

SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Using M cast on 43 sts as RIB T1/1 knit 19 rows, COL. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row. Depress both TUCK buttons and release card. Work in tuck patt to RC4. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 16th row × 11 [65 sts]. Knit to RC168. With wrong side facing pick up sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto same Ns. Using st st T10 knit 1 row and latch off.

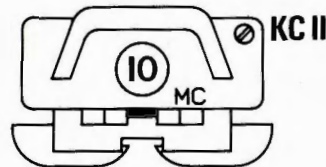
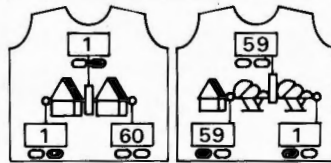
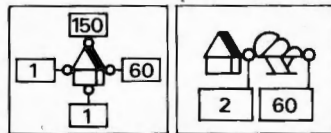
MAKE-UP

Place crosses onto garment as illustrated and graft into position. Join side and sleeve seams.



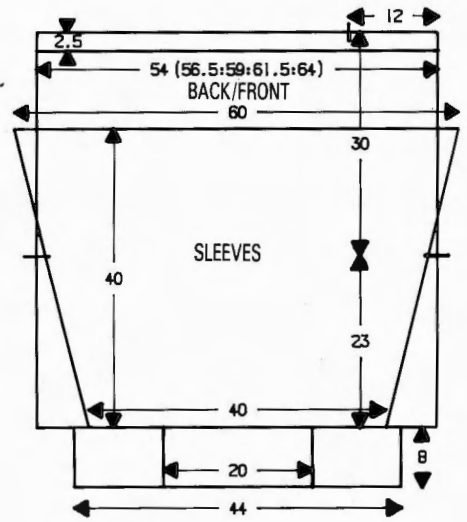
LADY'S SWEATER

MACHINES: C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** LAINES ANNY BLATT Angor'anny; M - 525 (550, 575, 600, 625) g (Blanc 625), Con Col - 25 g all sizes (Noir 636) (70% angora, 30% wool, 470 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 40 sts = 14.2 cm and 60 rows = 16 cm (aprox T10). **RIB:** 2 × 1 N arrangement on both KH and KR Pitch H, T4/4.



BACK

Using WY cast on 150 (158, 166, 172, 180) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR, 000. Change to M T10 and knit to RC86. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC112. Waste knit 34 sts at each end for shoulders. Trans every 2nd st to adjacent N, leaving empty Ns in WP, 000. Inc 1 st at beg of next and every foll row × 10, cast off 92 (100, 108, 114, 122) sts.



FRONT

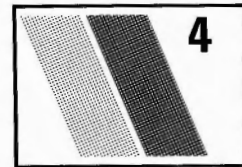
As BACK, work "Cat Face" as a single motif, with M in FA and Con Col in FB starting at RC22 above WY cast on sts. Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts onto Ns with right sides together. Using M T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

SLEEVES

Push 168 Ns into WP. With wrong side facing pick up 168 sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns, COR, 000. Using M T10 knit to RC5. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 5th row × 28 [112 sts]. Knit to RC150 and waste knit. **Cuffs:** Using M cast on over 56 Ns as RIB, 000. Knit to RC32. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns - 2 per N. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Waistbands:** Push 122 (130, 138, 144, 152) Ns into WP. With wrong side facing place sts from waist edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row. Trans to 2 × 2 rib making sts as necessary. T4/4 knit to RC31. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

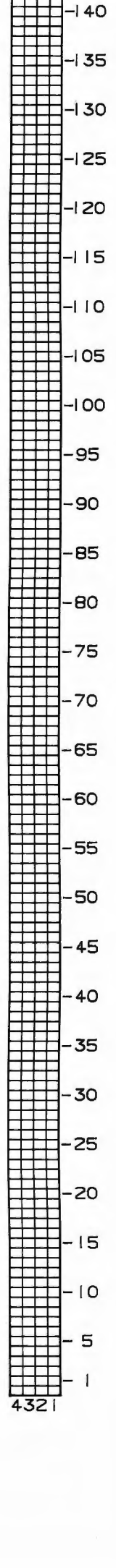
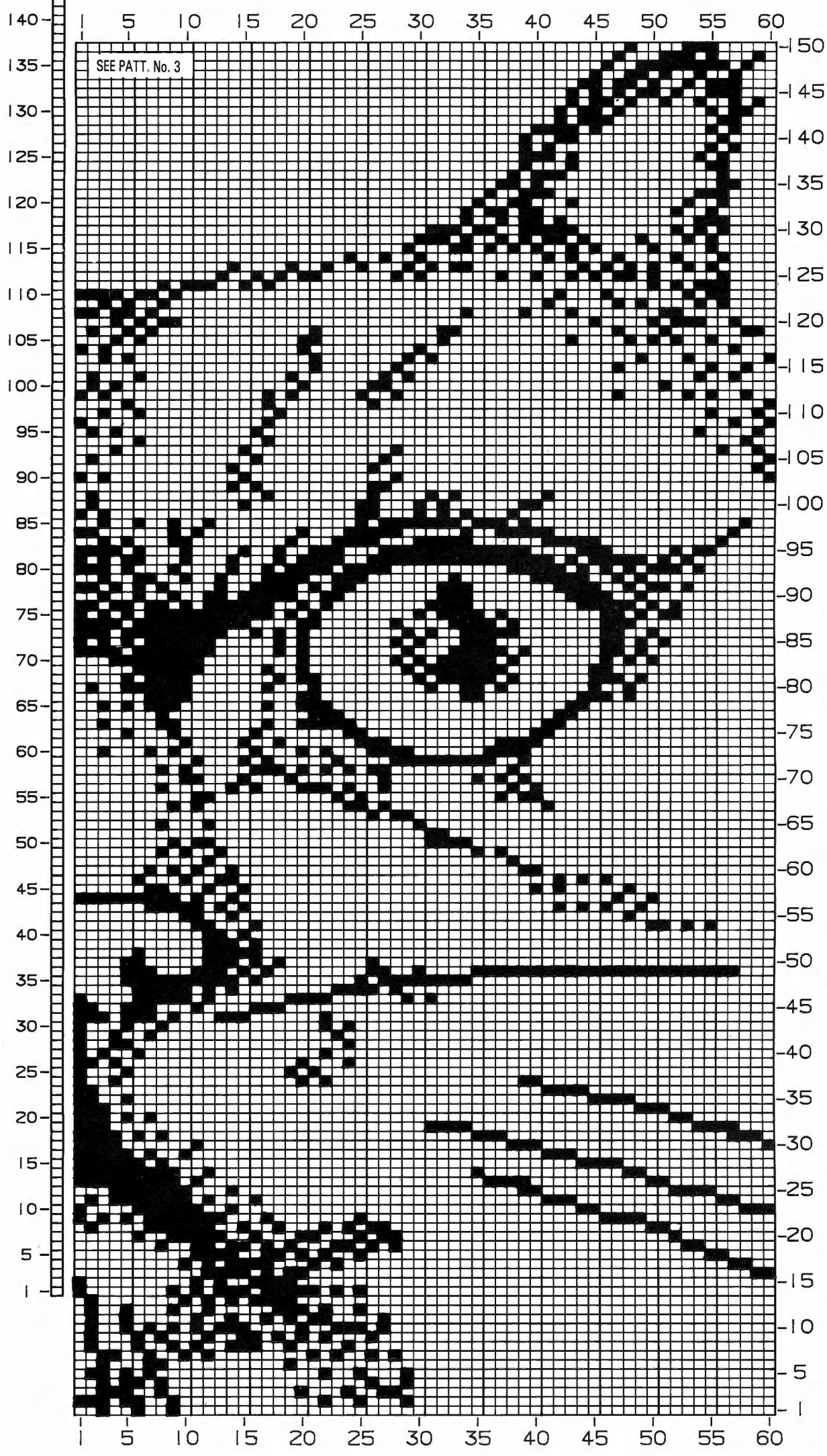
MAKE-UP

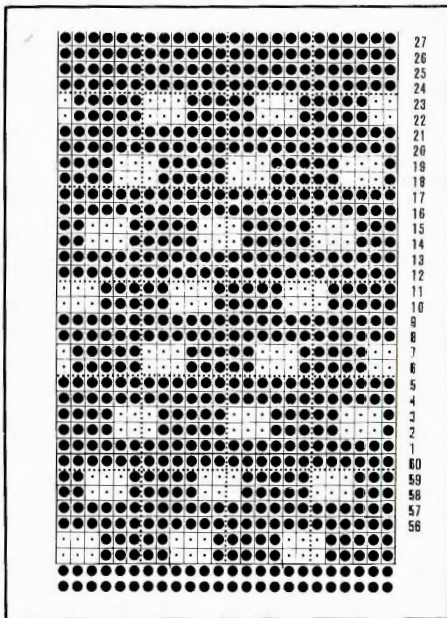
Join neckband seams, fold to inside to form picot edge and stitch into position. Join side and sleeve seams.



SKIP STITCH CARDIGAN

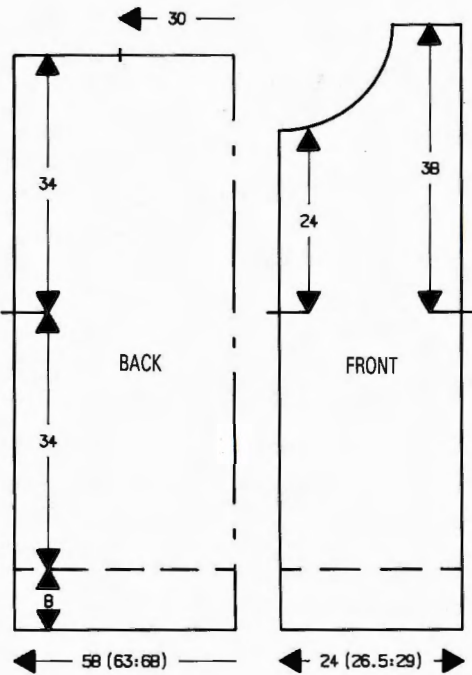
MACHINES: E with KR. **MATERIALS:** LISTER HAND KNITTING Angoralook DK; M - 440 (460, 480) g (Gentle Smoke 820), Con Col - 160 (180, 200) g (Orange 832), (50% acrylic, 50% nylon, 293 m/100 g); 5 buttons. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86/91 (96/101, 106/111) cm. **TENSION:** Skip patt - 20 sts = 12.5 cm and 30 rows = 11.5 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** 2 × 2 T 2/2, using 2 ends of M together. **NOTES:** Skip/stripe patt - *with K-Carr set to KC depress both PART buttons, using Con Col knit 2 rows, change to M and knit 2 rows*. Rep from * to *. Purl side is right side of fabric.





BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using 2 ends of M cast on 94 (102, 110) sts as RIB and knit 21 rows. Trans to KH. *Set K-Carr to KC. T6 knit 1 row. 000. Depress both PART buttons, release card and work in skip/stripe patt throughout* to RC88, 000. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Knit to RC88. Waste knit centre 48 sts. Waste knit rem 23 (27, 31) sts at each side for shoulders.



RIGHT FRONT

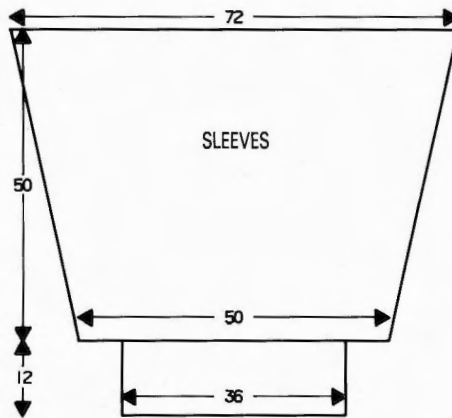
Lock card on row 1. Using 2 ends of M cast on 38 (42, 46) sts as RIB and work as BACK to RC62 above WY markers, COR.

Neck shaping

At beg of next and every foll alt row cast off 4 sts \times 1, 3 sts \times 2, then 1 st every 3rd row \times 5. Knit to RC98. With wrong side of BACK facing, place sts from matching shoulder onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

LEFT FRONT

As RIGHT FRONT reversing shapings.



SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Using WY cast on 80 sts and knit a few rows ending with COL, 000. Work as BACK from * to * to RC7. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 7th row \times 17 [114 sts]. Knit to RC130. With wrong side of BACK/Front facing pick up 114 sts evenly along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. *Cuffs:* Using 2 ends of M cast on 58 sts and knit 30 rows. Trans to KH. Using 1 end of M, T6 knit 1 row. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

NECKBAND

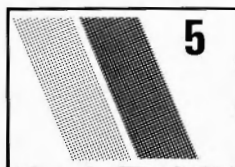
Using 2 ends of M cast on 98 sts as RIB, 000. Beg with T0/0 and inc tension by $\frac{1}{3}$ every 2 rows knit to RC24. Trans to KH. Using 1 end of M, T6 knit 1 row. With wrong side of garment facing, pick up sts from around neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

BUTTONBAND/BUTTONHOLE BAND

Buttonband: Using 2 ends of M cast on 110 sts as RIB, 000. T4/4 knit to RC20. Trans to KH. Using 1 end of M T6 knit 1 row. With wrong side of garment facing, pick up sts along left front edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. *Buttonhole band:* As Buttonband, work 5 \times 6 st buttonholes on row 10.

MAKE-UP

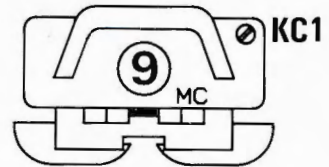
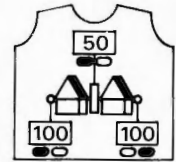
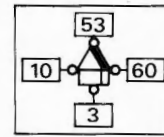
Join side and sleeve seams. Neaten buttonholes and attach buttons.



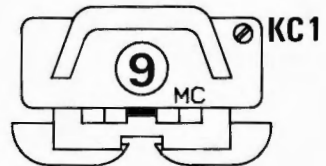
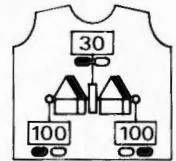
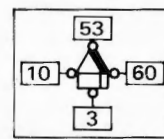
LADY'S FAIRISLE SWEATER

MACHINES: C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** Pingouin Esprit d'Angora; M - 280 (300, 320, 340, 360) g (Noir 22) (10% angora, 30% acrylic, 60% polyamide, 373 m/100 g). PINGOUIN Pingofine; A - 70 (80, 90, 100, 110) g (Cuivre 424), B - 90 (100, 110, 120, 130) g (Moutarde 423) (75% acrylic, 25% wool, 406 m/100 g). LAINES ANNY BLATT; C

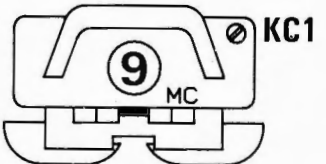
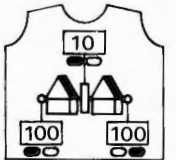
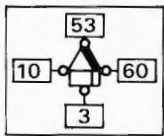
- 70 (80, 90, 100, 110) g (Shade 2398) (70% angora, 30% wool, 450 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle patt - 40 sts = 14.2 cm and 60 rows = 17 cm (approx T9). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T2/2 slide lever II. **NOTES:** For diagram see Patt No 3.

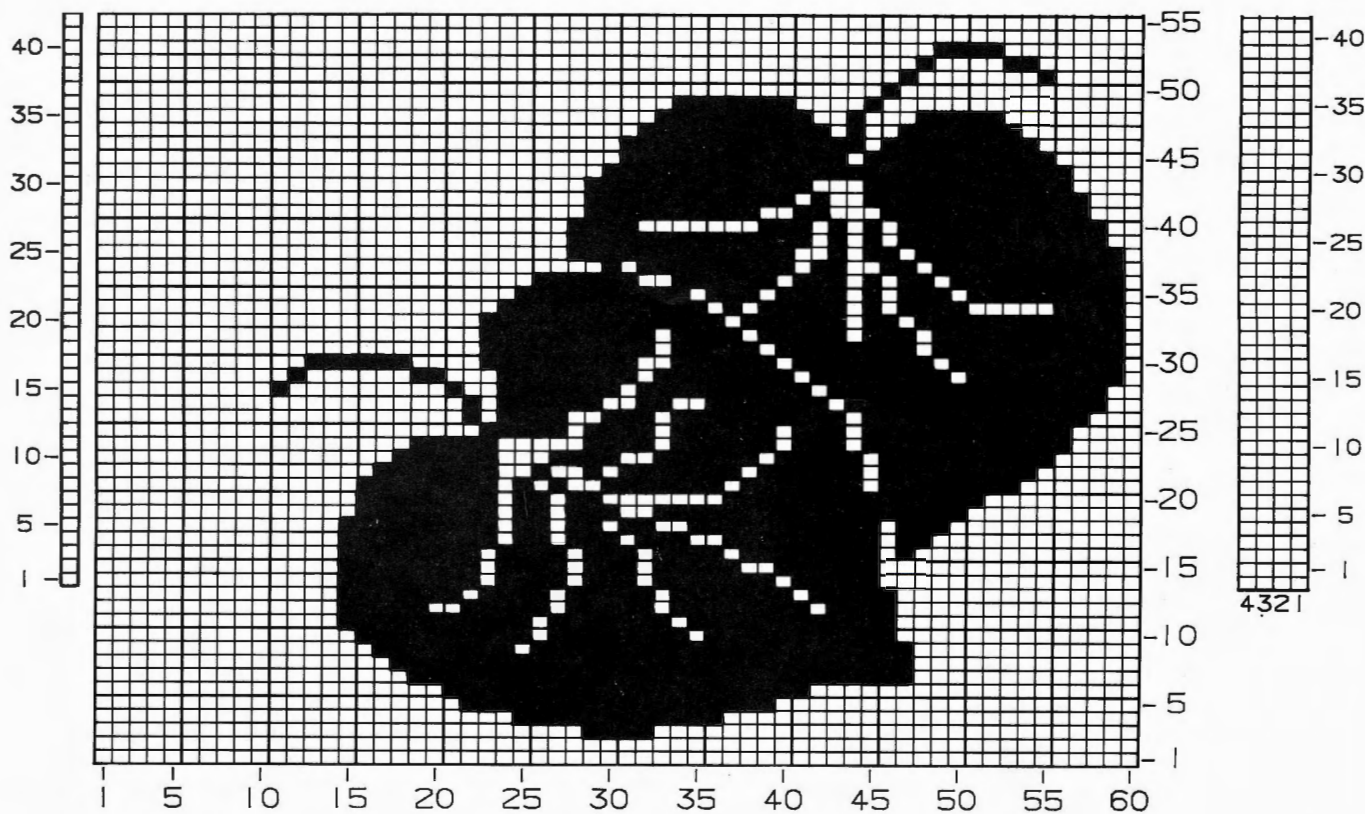

BACK/FRONT

Insert Myler sheet or input stitch patt. Using WY cast on 151 (159, 165, 173, 179) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR. Change to M, T9, 000. Knit to RC5, COL. Set for first row of fairisle - First Needle Position Y50. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1



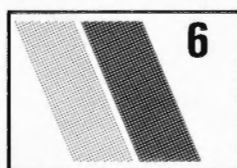
row to select Ns. With M in FA and A in FB knit to top of "leaf". Cont in M only to RC63, COL. Set for first row of fairisle - First Needle Position Y30. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns. With M in FA and B in FB knit to RC80. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Cont in fairisle to top of "leaf". Cont in M only to RC121, COL. Set for first row of fairisle - First Needle Position Y10. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns. With M in FA and C in FB knit to top of "leaf". Cont in M only to RC180. Trans to RIB, T3/3, Slide Lever I, knit to RC193. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off. **Waist ribs:** Push 123 (131, 135, 147, 151) Ns to WP. With wrong side facing place sts from first row knitted in M at waist edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. Using M T10 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, T2/2, Slide Lever I, 000. Knit to RC33. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off. Join 12 cm each side of neck opening.

SLEEVES

Using WY cast on 112 sts and knit a few rows ending with COL, 000. Set for 14th row of fairisle - First Needle Position - Y50. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns. With M in FA and A in FB knit to top of "leaf" and, AT THE SAME TIME, inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 5th row \times 28 [168 sts]. Set for first row of fairisle - First Needle Position Y30 and with M in FA and B in FB cont inc's, knit to top of "leaf". Set for first row of fairisle - First Needle Position Y10 and with M in FA and C in FB knit to RC142. Waste knit, turn work and replace sts onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. **Cuffs:** Push 56 Ns into WP. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns - 2 per N. T10 knit 1 row, trans to RIB, 000. Knit to RC33. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

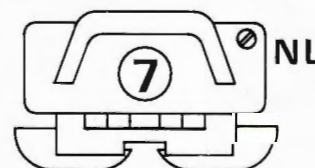
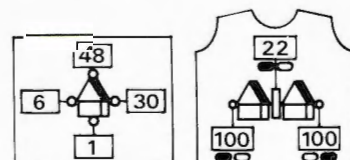
LACE/BOBBLE/CABLE SWEATER

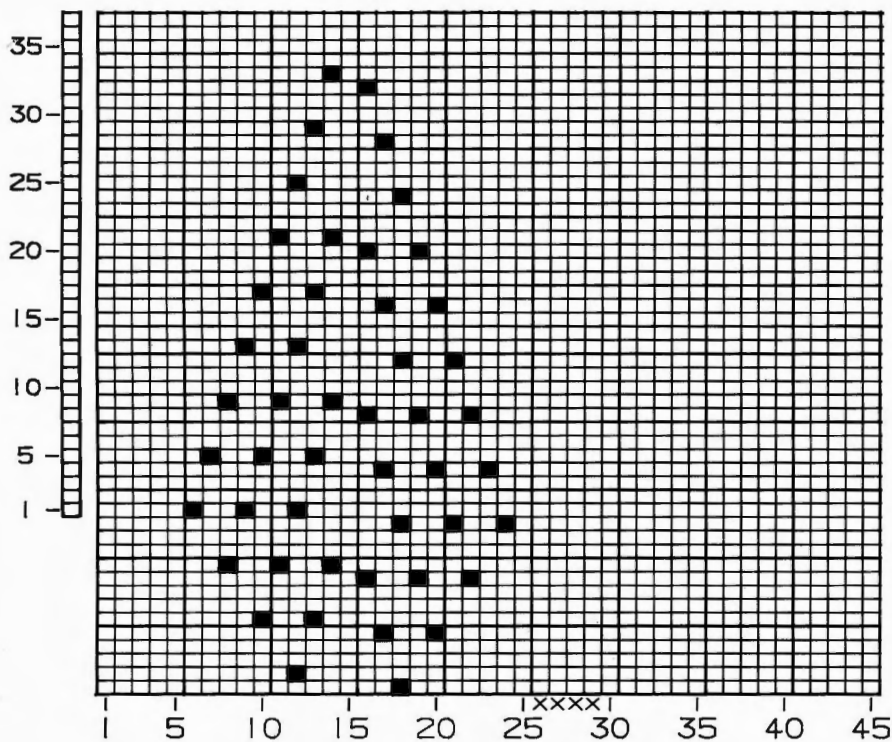
MACHINES: C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** LISTER HAND KNITTING Motoravia 4-ply; M - 490 (500, 510, 520, 530) g (Turquoise 1697) (100% pure wool, 398 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Lace/Bobble/Cable patt - 40 sts = 15.3 cm and 60 rows = 13.6 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T2/2 - cuffs and waist ribs, T3/3 neck edge. **NOTES:** Cables are worked across sts marked "x" on Myler sheet - cable 2 over 2 on 8th and 12th row of each patt repeat and on 15th row work bobbles on same Ns as follows: COR, disengage RC tripper. Set K-Carr to H and push all Ns to left of first bobble to HP. Knit 1 row, COL. Push all Ns to right of first bobble to HP. Knit 7 rows over 4 bobble sts. COR, pick up sts from first row of bobble and place onto Ns. Push to UWP all Ns to left of first bobble up to and including Ns for second bobble - work second and subsequent bobbles in the same manner as first. At end of row reset RC tripper and manually move RC forward 1 row. Use diagram from Pattern no 3 changing the measurements from waist rib to underarm to 24.5 cm and underarm to beg of neck rib to 30 cm, also length of sleeve to 43.5 cm. **PROGRAM:** Patt I and II are worked alternately, program the different First Needle

Position each time before you beg the first row of the next patt repeat. Beg with Patt I (1 patt repeat = 48 rows on Myler sheet - 24 rows of st st).

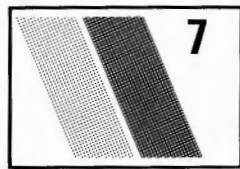
Using WY cast on 141 (147, 155, 161, 167) sts and knit a few rows, 000. Set for first patt row. Change to M T7 and work in patt to RC108. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC132. Trans to RIB T3/3 knit 10 rows and cast off. *Waist ribs:* Using M cast on 121 (125, 133, 137, 143) sts as RIB and knit 32 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, replace sts from waist edge of BACK/FRONT onto same Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Join shoulder seams leaving an opening of approx 30 cm.

SLEEVES

Using WY cast on 88 sts and knit a few rows, 000. Set for first patt row. Change to M T7 work in patt to RC14. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 5th row x 34. [156 sts] Knit to RC192. Waste knit. Turn work and replace sts onto Ns. With right sides together pick up sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto same Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. *Cuffs:* Using M cast on 71 sts as RIB and knit 32 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, replace sts from cuff edge onto same Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join side and sleeve seams.



TUCK SWEATER/TOP

MACHINES: A, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** Lister Hand Knitting Motoravia 4-ply; M - 290 (300, 310, 320, 330) g (Blackcurrant 1654), A - 140 (150, 160, 170, 180) g (Bottle 1694), B - 140 (150, 160, 170, 180) g (Cherry 1658), C - 140 (150, 160, 170, 180) g (Kingfisher 1698) (100% pure new wool, 398 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Tuck Stitch - 40 sts = 15.3 cm and 60 rows = 12 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T2/2. **NOTES:** Colour sequence for stripe/tuck pattern: *2 rows M, 2 rows A, 2 rows B, 2 rows C*. Repeat from * to * throughout. Purl side is right side of fabric.

BACK

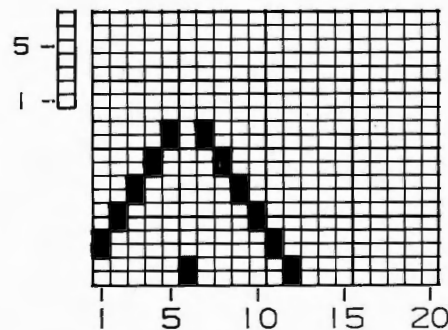
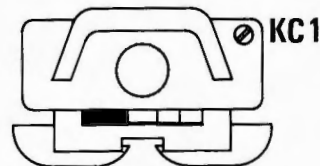
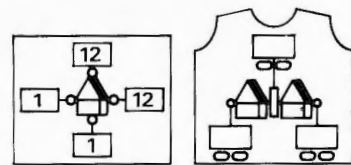
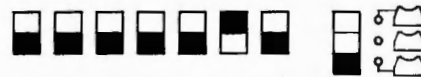
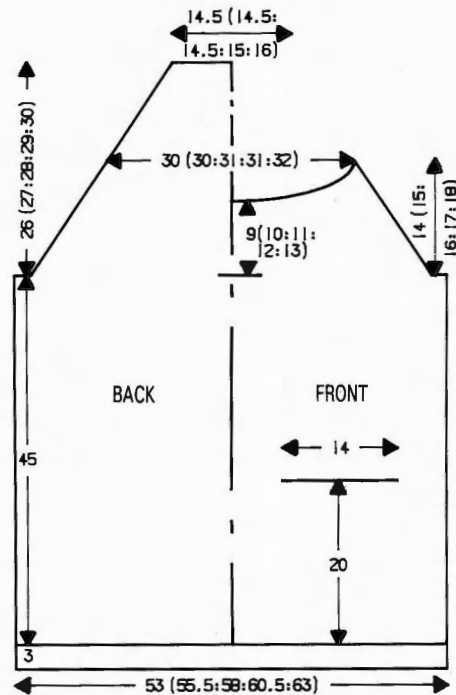

Raglan shaping

Cast off 7 (8, 9, 10, 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 000. Knit to RC130 (136, 140, 144, 150) and AT THE SAME TIME dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 3rd row x 44 (46, 47, 48, 50). Waste knit rem 37 (37, 39, 41, 43) sts.

FRONT

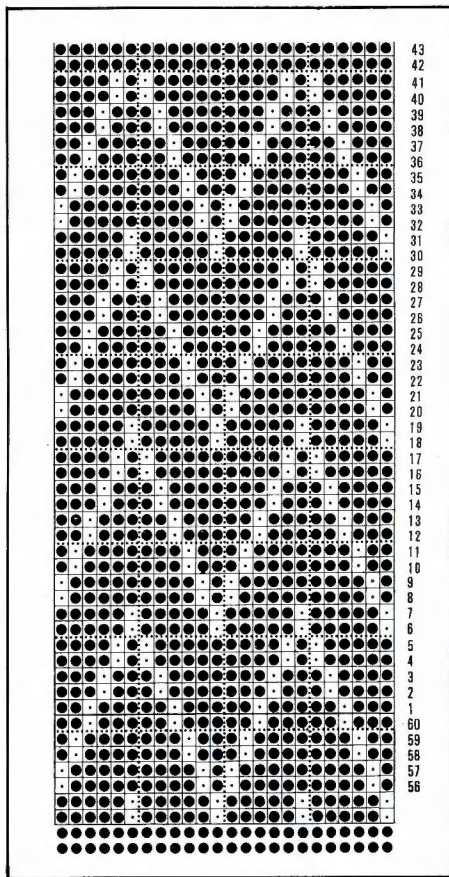

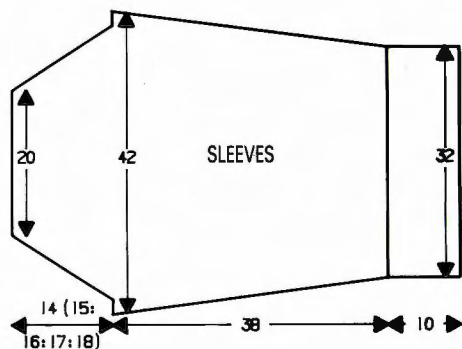

Using M cast on 83 sts as RIB and knit 50 rows, 000. T7 set for first patt row. Work in Stripe/Tuck patt to RC5. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 15th row \times 12 [107 sts], COR.



Raglan shaping

Cast off 7 (8, 9, 10, 10) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 000. Knit to RC2 (7, 1, 6, 4). Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 3rd (3rd, 4th, 4th, 5th) row \times 21 (20, 19, 18, 18) [53 sts rem]. Knit to RC70 (76, 80, 86, 90) and waste knit.

YOKE

Using WY cast on 183 (183, 185, 185, 189) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR.

Change to M, T7 and knit 4 rows. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from right sleeve, front and left sleeve and place onto same Ns. T10 knit 1 row, 000. Trans to RIB T2/2 knit to RC20. T1 $\frac{3}{4}$ /1 $\frac{1}{4}$ knit to RC40. T1 $\frac{1}{2}$ /1 $\frac{1}{2}$ knit to RC54. Trans to KH and waste knit. Join raglan seams leaving one back seam open. Backstitch through first row knitted in M around edge of yoke.

NECKBAND

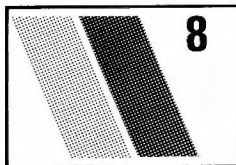
Bring 161 (161, 163, 165, 171) Ns to WP and with right side facing, replace sts from neck edge onto Ns distributing sts evenly along the row. T10 with M knit 1 row and trans to RIB, 000. T1 $\frac{3}{4}$ /1 $\frac{1}{4}$ knit to RC24, trans to KH. T7 knit 2 rows and waste knit.

COLLAR

Using M cast on 161 (161, 163, 165, 171) sts as RIB, 000. T2/2 Slide Lever I, knit to RC30. T2/2 Slide Lever II, knit to RC50. Trans to KH, T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Press outer edge of collar to form a curve.

MAKE-UP

Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Join 4th raglan seam. Sew collar to inside of neckband. Join pocket bag seams and sew pocket ribs into position. Join side and sleeve seams. Give final press.



LADY'S SWEATER/TOP

MACHINES: Garter Carriage. **MATERIALS:** BERGER DU NORD Douceur No 4; M - 650 (700, 750, 800, 850) g (Fuchsia 9191) (85% wool, 15% kid mohair, 250 m/100 g), 2 buttons. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Garter stitch patt - 40 sts = 17.3 cm and 60 rows = 18.5 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 2 \times 2 T8 for BACK, FRONT and POCKET ribs. T6 for Cuffs. **NOTES:** The Card/Electronic pattern was taken from the Brother pattern book for the "Automatic Knitting Carriage" which contains a large selection of designs for the Garter Carriage but of course there is no reason why you cannot use some of them for fairisle designs as well.

BACK

Using M COBH 122 (128, 134, 140, 146) sts and work in RIB to RC12. Change to Card/Myler sheet illustrated and work in garter patt to RC144, 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row \times 40 (39, 41, 40, 42), then every row \times 2 (6, 6, 10, 10). Knit to RC84 (86, 90, 92, 96), change to K-Carr and waste knit.

POCKETS

Using M COBH over Ns 21 to 52 inclusive and work in garter patt to RC48. Change to K-Carr and waste knit.

FRONT

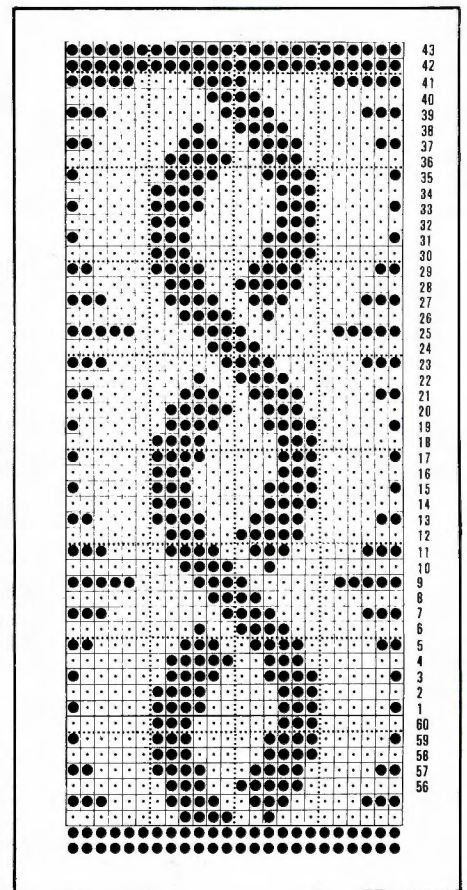
As BACK to RC64 above RIB. **Place pockets:** Using K-Carr waste knit sts on Ns 21 to 52 inclusive on both sides of '0'. With right side facing place last row knitted in M on to empty Ns. Change to Garter Carriage and cont in patt to RC144, 000.

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and alt rows \times 20 (19, 21, 21, 22) then every row \times 4 (8, 8, 11, 12) and AT THE SAME TIME at RC30 (32, 36, 38, 42) work ...

Neck shaping

(Note Card/Myler sheet position.) Place a WY marker on 4th N each side of '0'. Using a separate length of yarn cast off centre 20 (20, 22, 22, 24) sts. Change to K-Carr and waste knit sts at left. Using Garter Carriage cont in patt, knit 1 row, COL. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 3 sts \times 7, then 4 sts \times 1. Replace sts at left back onto Ns and knit to match right side reversing shapings.



SLEEVES

Set Card/Myler sheet for first patt row. Using M COBH 74 sts, T6 set for 2 \times 2 rib, 000. Knit to RC40, 000. T10 work in patt to RC10, inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 10th row \times 12 [98 sts]. Knit to RC122, 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th row \times 0 (0, 1, 2, 4), then every alt row \times 20 (22, 23, 22, 20), then every row \times 4 (2, 0, 0, 0). Knit to RC46 (48, 52, 54, 58) and waste knit.

HALF YOKE

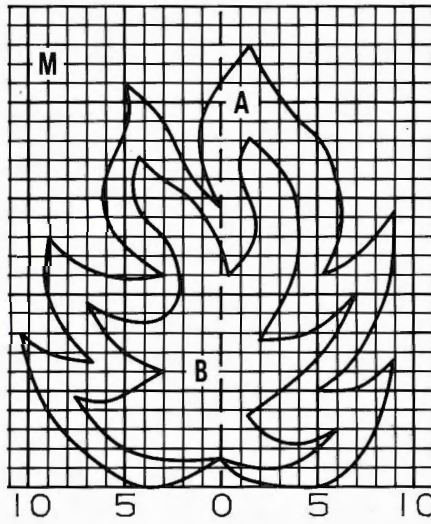
Using WY and K-Carr cast on 76 (76, 78, 78, 80) sts and knit a few rows. Change to M T10 and knit 3 rows. With wrong side facing, pick up sts from one sleeve and front neck to WY markers and place onto Ns. Knit 1 row. Set for 2 × 2 rib. T9 knit 13 rows. Change to K-Carr and waste knit. Replace sts back onto Ns as 2 × 1 rib (place the 2 plain sts onto 1 N). Set for 2 × 1 rib. T8 knit 13 rows. Change to K-Carr and waste knit. Replace sts back onto Ns as 1 × 1 rib (place 2 purl sts onto 1 N). Set for 1 × 1 rib. T8 knit 12 rows. Change to K-Carr and waste knit. Work second half yoke, join YOKE to BACK raglan.

COLLAR

Using M COBH 110 (110, 114, 114, 118) sts as RIB, 000. Begin with highest tension and reducing tension by $\frac{1}{3}$ every 2 rows. Knit to RC30. With right side facing, pick up sts from neck edge and place onto Ns. Using K-Carr T10 knit 3 rows and waste knit.

MAKE-UP

Block and press LIGHTLY all garment pieces. Join raglans, side and sleeve seams. Stitch pockets into position. *Pocket ribs*: Replace sts from pocket opening onto Ns. Set for 2 × 2 rib, T8 knit 11 rows, T10 knit 1 row and using Garter Carriage cast off. Stitch pocket ribs into position. Backstitch collar to neck edge. Press collar lightly. *Buttonband*: Using WY and K-Carr cast on 28 sts and knit a few rows. Change to M T9, knit 12 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T9 knit 12 rows. Make a hem by placing first row knitted in M onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up sts evenly along left front neck opening and place onto same Ns, using backstitch, cast off. *Buttonhole band*: As buttonband making 2 buttonholes at RC6 and RC19. Neaten buttonholes, stitch bands into position between WY markers. Attach buttons.

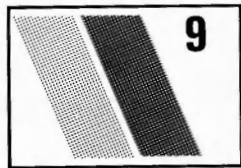
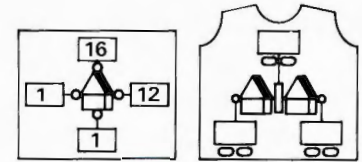
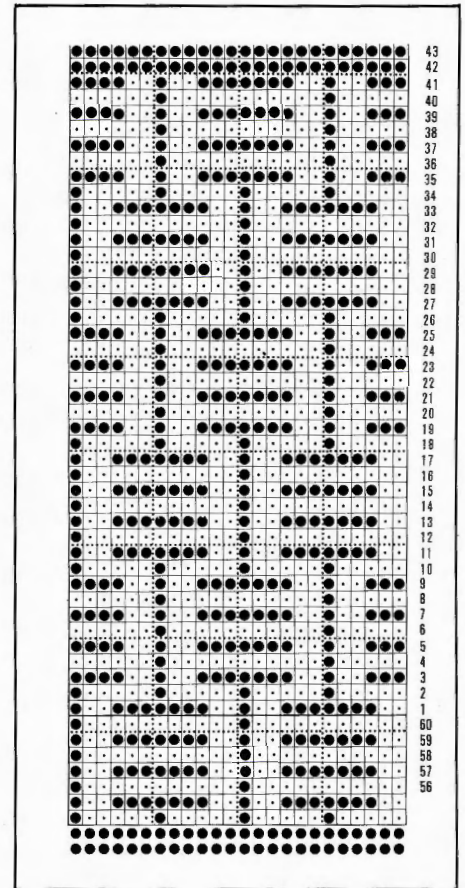

LADY'S JACKET

MACHINES: Garter Carriage and KR. **MATERIALS:** LISTER HAND KNITTING Richmond DK; M - 390 (400, 410) g (Olive 3200), A - 250 (260, 270) g (Aubergine 3202), B - 240 (250, 260) g (Fresh Green 3196), (45% nylon, 40% acrylic, 15% wool, 320 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86/91 (96/101, 106/111) cm. **TENSION:** Garter/Stripe patt - 40 sts = 14.2 cm and 60 rows = 14.2 cm (approx T8). **RIB:** Using KH and KR 1 × 1 T5/5. **NOTES:** Stripe sequence - 8 rows M, 8 rows A, 8 rows B. Use diagram from Pattern No. 14 with the foil alterations: top of hem to underarm - 36 cm, underarm to shoulder on front - 36 cm, underarm to shoulder on back - 32 cm and across top of sleeve 68 cm. 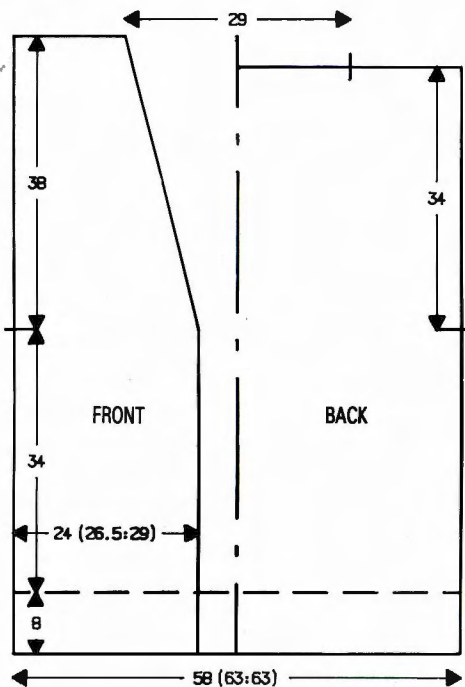

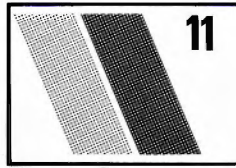

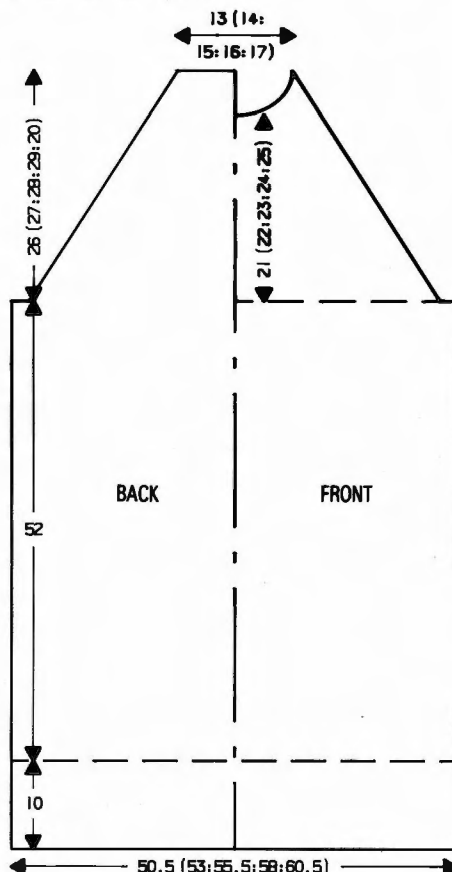

T3/3. **NOTES:** To work fully-fashioned dec's, counting from edge of work, trans sts on 4th and 5th Ns from edge to 6th and 7th Ns, move sts on Ns 1, 2 and 3 inwards to close space. To work fully-fashioned inc's, counting from edge of work, move sts 1, 2 and 3 one N outwards, pick up the loop from st from previous row below empty N, and place onto empty N.

BACK

Using M cast on 155 (161, 170, 176, 182) sts as RIB and knit 44 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T6 working in st st knit to RC218, 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 4 (3, 4, 4, 3) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 27 (28, 29, 30, 31). Knit to RC110 (114, 118, 122, 126) and waste knit rem 39 (43, 46, 48, 52) sts.

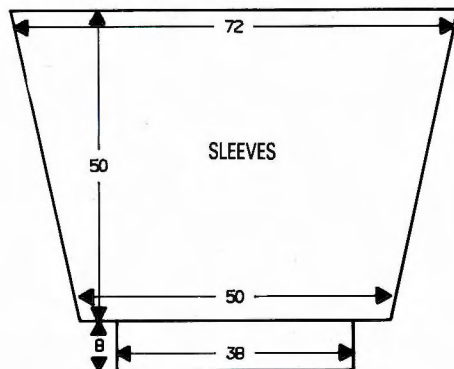

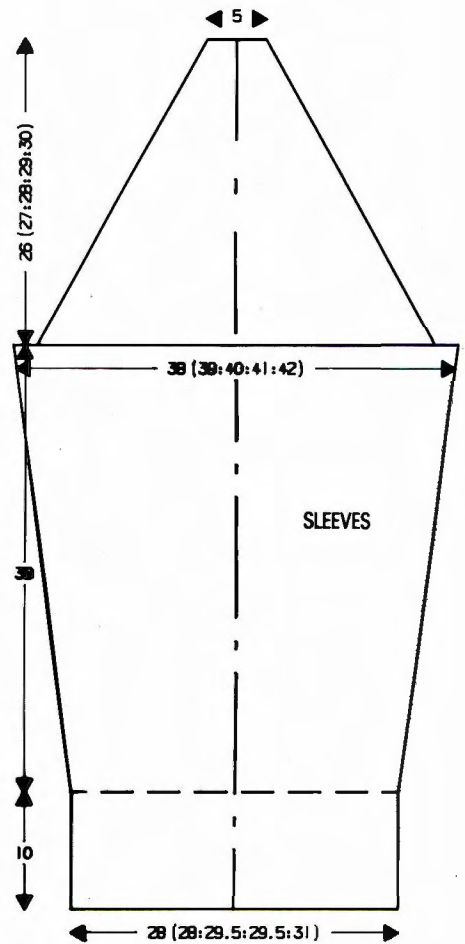

Trans to RIB knit 29 rows. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

FRONT BANDS AND MAKE-UP

Using M cast on 28 sts as 1 × 1 rib. T5/5 knit until band is long enough to fit from hem to WY marker at centre back neck. Waste knit, join to front opening and adjust to fit. If you would like buttonholes, mark button positions on first band, then knit a second



FRONT

As BACK to RC88 (92, 96, 100, 104) above beg of raglan shaping.

Neck shaping

Cont raglan shaping and, AT THE SAME TIME, waste knit centre 9 (13, 16, 18, 22) sts, push all Ns at left into HP, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 3 sts × 1, 2 sts × 1, and 1 st × 7. Knit to RC110 (114, 118, 122, 126) and bind of rem 3 sts. Knit second side to match reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using M cast on 86 (86, 90, 90, 94) sts as RIB and knit 50 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T6 knit 10 rows. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 8th row × 15 (17, 17, 18, 18). Knit to RC160. [116 (120, 124, 126, 130) sts], 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 2 (2, 2, 3, 3) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit 8 rows. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 24 (25, 26, 26, 27). Knit to RC110 (114, 118, 122, 126) and waste knit rem 16 sts.

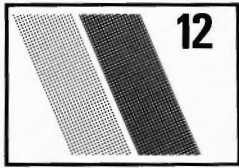
NECKBAND

Join three raglan seams leaving one back seam open. Push 126 (126, 130, 130, 134) Ns into WP. With right side facing pick up sts from neck edge and place onto Ns. T6 knit 1 row. Trans to 2 × 2 rib T3/3, knit 24 rows. Trans to KH. T6 knit 2 rows and waste knit.

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** TWILLEY'S Gold Dust '20'; M - 15 (16, 17) × 100 m reels (Green - shade 34, Purple - shade 43) (37% metalised polyester, 53% viscose, 10% nylon, 790 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96) cm. **TENSION:** 2 × 1 N arrangement on both KH and KR, Pitch H - 40 sts = 10.5 cm and 60 rows = 12 cm (approx T3/3). **NOTES:** Only Ns on KH are counted throughout. Work fully fashioned shaping keeping end 3 sts on KH.

BACK

Using M cast on over 176 (185, 194) Ns as RIB and knit to RC200, 000.

Armhole shaping

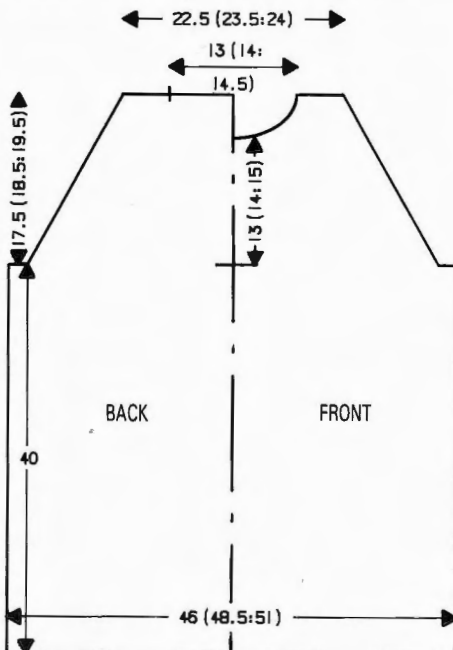

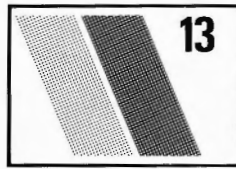

TWILLEY'S Goldfingering; Con Col - 200 (220, 240, 260, 280) g (Green WG34) (20% metalised polyester, 80% viscose, 500 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Using M over racking patt (see SKIRT) - 40 sts = 12.5 cm and 60 rows = 11.8 cm (approx T3/3). Fairisle patt - 40 sts = 11.7 cm and 60 rows = 15 cm (approx T5). **RIB:** Cuffs and neckband: Flat rib - every N on KH in WP and 1 × 1 on KR. **NOTES:** Use diagram from Patt No 2 changing measurement from top of waist rib to underarm to 14.5 cm. Length of skirt 64 cm.

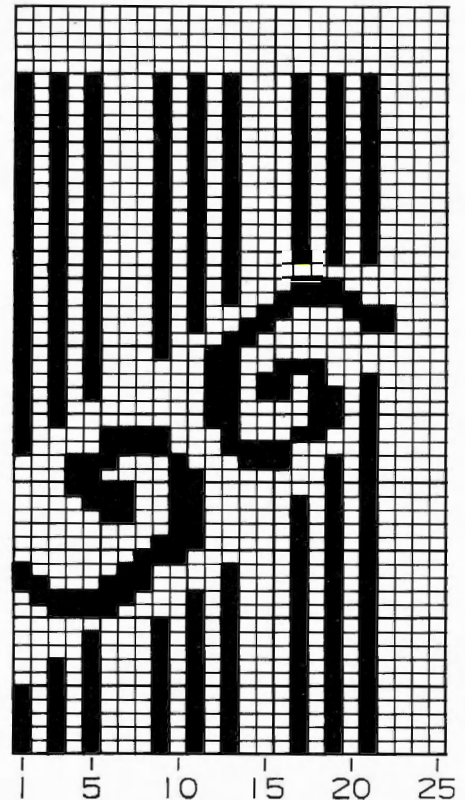
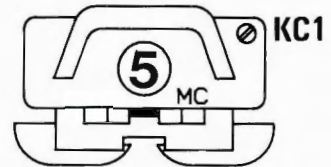
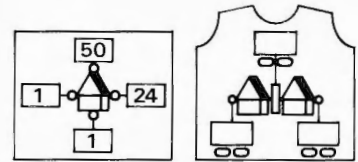

FRONT BODICE

Set for first fairisle row. Using WY cast on 166 (174, 182, 190, 198) sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. Change to M, T5. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns, 000. With M in FA and Con Col in FB work in fairisle to RC60. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000****. Cont in fairisle to RC76, COR***** (note fairisle row), 000. Cast off centre 10 sts. Push Ns at left to HP. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 5 sts × 3, 4 sts × 3, 3 sts × 3 and 2 sts × 3****. Knit to RC50 ***** and waste knit rem 36 (40, 44, 48, 52) sts. Return Ns at left to WP, set to fairisle row noted and knit to match right side reversing shapings*****.

Neckband

Using M cast on 133 sts as FNR. Pitch P trans to Flat Rib (see RIB) T2/2 Pitch H knit 3 rows. *Change to Con Col knit 2



rows. Change to M knit 2 rows*. Rep from * to * × 3, AT THE SAME TIME, inc tension 1/3 every 2 rows. Pitch P trans KR sts to KH. T5 knit 1 row. With wrong side facing pick up 133 sts along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off.

BACK BODICE

As FRONT BODICE to ****. Cont in fairisle to RC92. Cont as FRONT BODICE from ***** to *****. Knit to RC26. Cont as FRONT BODICE from ***** to *****.

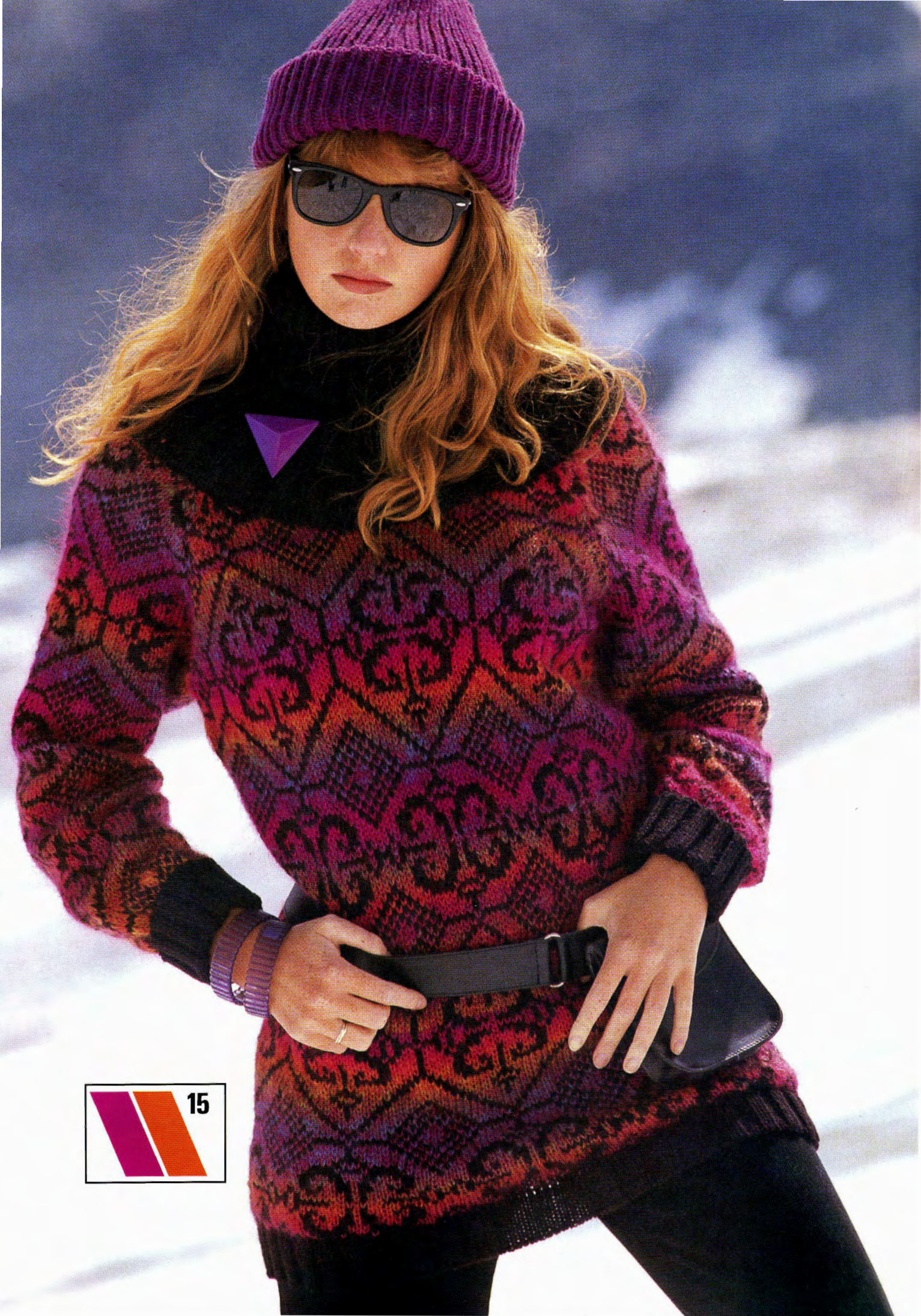

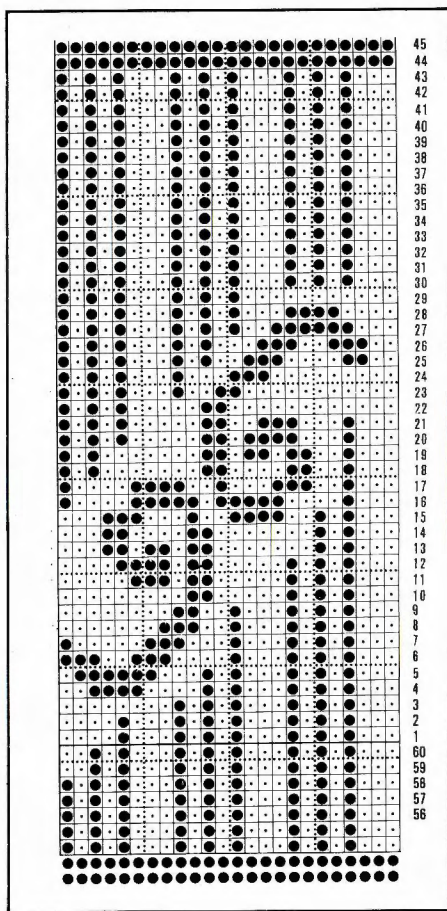








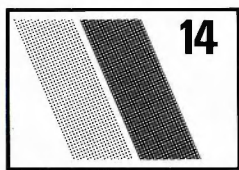

Press lightly **BODICE** and **SLEEVES**. Push 159 (165, 171, 177, 183) Ns to WP. With right side facing replace sts from waist of front bodice onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. With wrong side facing place sts from front skirt onto same Ns. Back stitch cast off. Work **BACK** to match. Join sleeves to armhole edge between WY markers. Join side and sleeve seams.



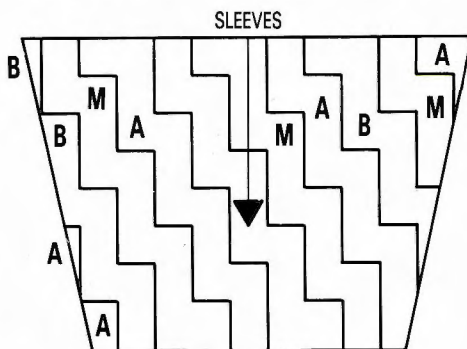
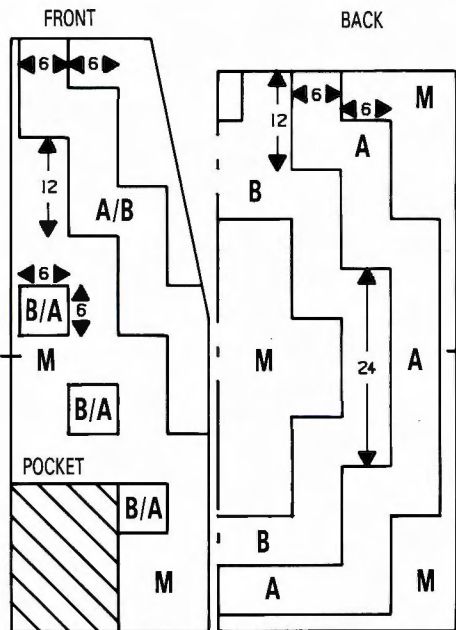

age if you intend to work the garment with the Intarsia Carriage - Intarsia Carriage and K-Carr tensions can be very different) - 20 sts = 13.5 cm and 30 rows = 17.5 cm (approx T8). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T2/2. **NOTES:** Draw garment diagram onto KL sheet in half scale to required size. Draw intarsia design as required in half scale. It is usual with D or E machines to work the tension swatch over 20 sts and 30 rows, however when working in half scale measure across 40 sts and 30 rows and use the Stitch Scale from KL set to correspond (not from machine set). SET KL TO TRIP ONCE EVERY ROW

PROCEDURE

Work tension swatch. Draw garment diagram onto KL sheet in half scale. Draw intarsia design onto KL sheet also in half scale. Select Stitch Scale and set KL for rows. Work **Pocket bag:** Using WY cast on required no of sts and knit a few rows. Change to M and knit required number of rows. Waste knit. Work **BACK** remembering to place WY markers for underarm, and casting off for centre **BACK** neck, waste knit shoulders. Work **FRONT** and placing pocket bags, remembering to place WY markers for underarm and waste knit shoulders. Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. Using M T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Draw **SLEEVES** diagram onto KL sheet - top of sleeve to base line. 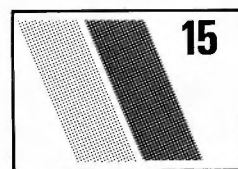

ARGYLL WOOLS Chameleon; Con Col - 180 (200, 220, 240) g (Shade 644) (50% mohair, 47.5% acrylic, 2.5% nylon, 348 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle - 20 sts = 11.1 cm and 30 rows = 14.3 cm (approx T4). **RIB:** Using 2 ends of M - 2 × 2 T2/2. **NOTES:** Using diagram from patt No 7 omitting pockets and first size.

BACK

Insert card and set for first fairisle row. Using 2 ends of M cast on 102 (106, 110, 114) sts as RIB, 000. Knit to RC11. Trans to KH, COL. Set K-Carr to KC T4, knit 1 row, 000. With M in FA and Con Col in FB release card and work in fairisle to RC94, 000*.

Raglan

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit 2 rows. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 4 (6, 4, 6). Knit 2 rows, then dec 3 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row × 9 (8, 10, 9). Knit to RC56 (58, 60, 62). Waste knit rem 26 (28, 28, 30) sts.

FRONT

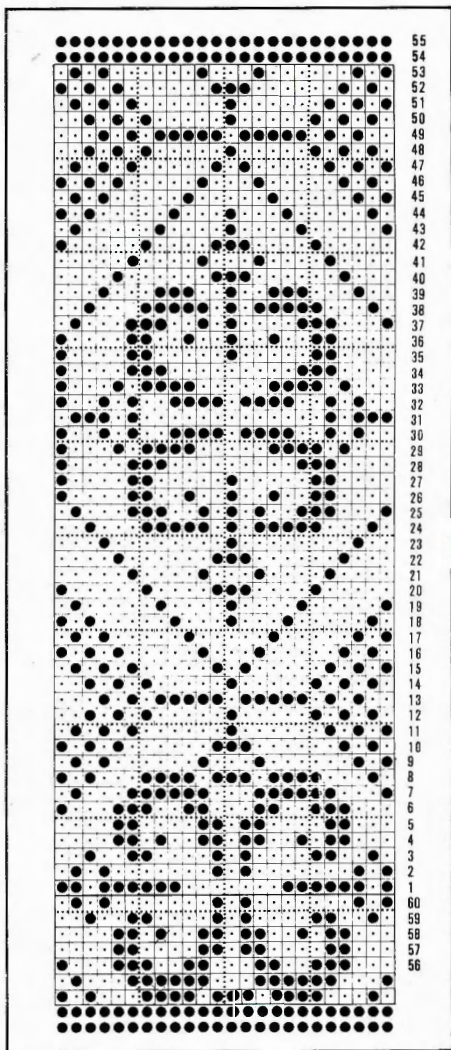

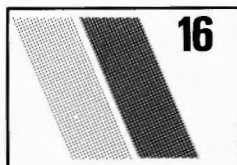

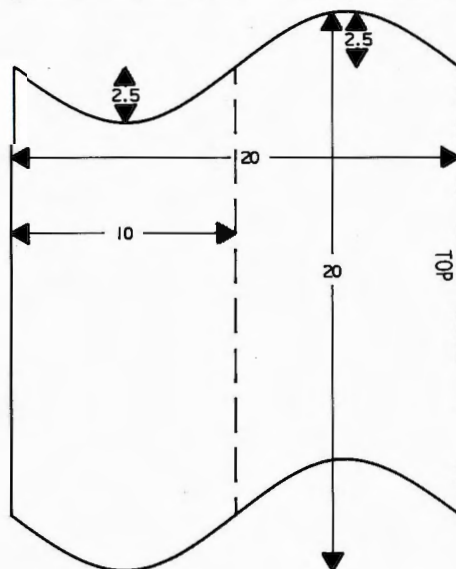

(81% mohair, 14% wool, 5% nylon, 203 m/100 g). A small amount of 4-ply in matching colour to sew up. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86/91 (96/101, 106/111) cm. **TENSION:** Intarsia/st st (when making your tension swatch use Intarsia Carriage if you intend to work the garment with the Intarsia Carriage - Intarsia Carriage and K-Carr tension can be very different) - 20 sts = 12.5 cm and 30 rows = 13.8 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T1/1. **NOTES:** Use diagram from patt no 14 and draw onto KL in half scale to required size. It is usual with D and E machines to work the tension swatch over 20 sts and 30 rows, however when working in half scale measure across 40 sts and 30 rows and use the Stitch Scale from KL set to correspond (not from machine set). SET KL TO TRIP ONCE EVERY ROW

Work tension swatch. Draw in half scale garment diagram onto KL sheet. Make a

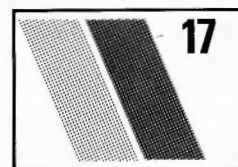

MACHINES: F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** ARGYLL WOOLS Laser; M - 215 (230, 245, 260, 275) g (Black 561), Con Col - 175 (190, 205, 220, 235) g (Yellow 571) (100% high bulk acrylic 495 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle - 40 sts = 15.5 cm and 60 rows = 17.5 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T2/2. **NOTES:** Use "Stitch World" pattern no. 6, set for all-over fairisle. For diagram see Patt No 3.

BACK/FRONT

Using M cast on 141 (147, 153, 159, 165) sts as RIB T4/4 and knit 11 rows, COL, 000. Trans all sts to KH and set for fairisle. T10 knit 1 row to select Ns. With M in FA and Con Col in FB knit in fairisle to RC92, 000. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Knit to RC80 and waste knit. Waist rib: push 121 (127, 133, 139, 145) Ns into WP. *Place sts from last row of fairisle back onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. Using M T10 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, 000. Knit to RC39. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch cast off*. Join shoulder seams.

SLEEVES

Push 156 Ns into WP, COL. With wrong side facing pick up sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns. Set for first row of fairisle patt. Using M T10 knit 1 row to select Ns. With M in FA and Con Col in FB work in fairisle patt to RC2. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 5th row × 26 [104 sts rem]. Knit to RC136 and waste

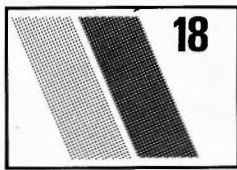

MACHINES: D or E with KR. **MATERIALS:** PHILDAR Geolite; M - 475 (485, 495, 505, 515) g (Roy 102) (41% rayon, 19% polyester, 17% kid mohair, 8% nylon, 8% wool, 7% acrylic, 172 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Cable patt - 20 sts = 13.3 cm and 30 rows = 15.7 cm (approx T9). **RIB:** Waist ribs and cuffs - 1 x 1 T2/2 slide Lever II. Neckband - 1 x 1 foll tensions as given. **NOTES:** Cable patt - trans every 5th sts to adjacent N and push empty Ns to NWP. *Knit 6 rows, cable 2 over 2 sts. Bring all Ns to HP. Set K-Carr to N*. Rep from * to * throughout. Ns in NWP are counted as sts throughout. When picking up sts for neckband, cuffs and at armholes and replacing them onto Ns, insert single transfer tool into loop between cables, twist and place loop onto N as an 'e' wrap stitch. For diagram see patt no. 2.

BACK

Using M cast on 80 (85, 90, 93, 98) sts as RIB and knit 36 rows. Trans to KH, 000. T9 arrange sts/Ns for cable patt (see NOTES). Work in cable patt to RC40. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC44.

Neck shaping

Using Nylon Cast-on Cord knit back by hand to NWP 47 (50, 52, 54, 56) sts at left, COR. Knit 2 rows. At neck edge on next and every foll alt row, using Nylon Cast-on Cord knit back by hand to NWP 5 sts x 1, 4 sts x 1*, 2 sts x 2 and 1 st x 1. Knit to RC58 and waste knit rem 19 (21, 24, 25, 28) sts. **Return 33 (35, 38, 39, 42) Ns at far left to WP and knit to match right side reversing shapings. Return centre 42 (43, 42, 43, 43) Ns to WP and waste knit.**

FRONT

As BACK to RC36 above WY markers.

Neck shaping

As BACK to * and 1 st x 5. Knit to RC60

and waste knit rem 19 (21, 24, 25, 28) sts. Cont as BACK from ** to **.

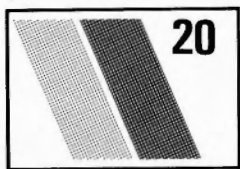

T10 knit 1 row and latch off. Cuffs: Push 41 Ns into WP. With wrong side facing pick up sts from cuff edge and place onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row (see NOTES), 000. Using M T9, knit 1 row. Trans to RIB and knit to RC19, T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

You have a choice of either working the black horizontal lines as continuous, in which case you must catch down the floats on the wrong side of the fabric or, working as the 0's and X's whereby at the meeting point of the black lines a white stitch is substituted.

BACK

Using M cast on 162 (168, 176, 184, 192) sts as RIB and knit 39 rows, COL. Trans to KH. Set for first fairisle row. Set K-Carr to KC, T10 knit 1 row to select Ns, 000. With M in FA and Con Col in FB T7 work in fairisle to



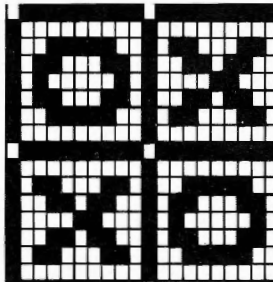

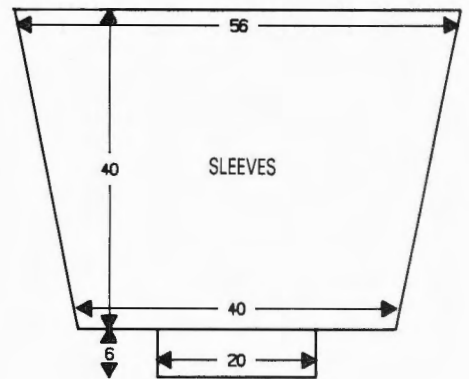

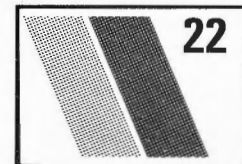

With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and cast off loosely.



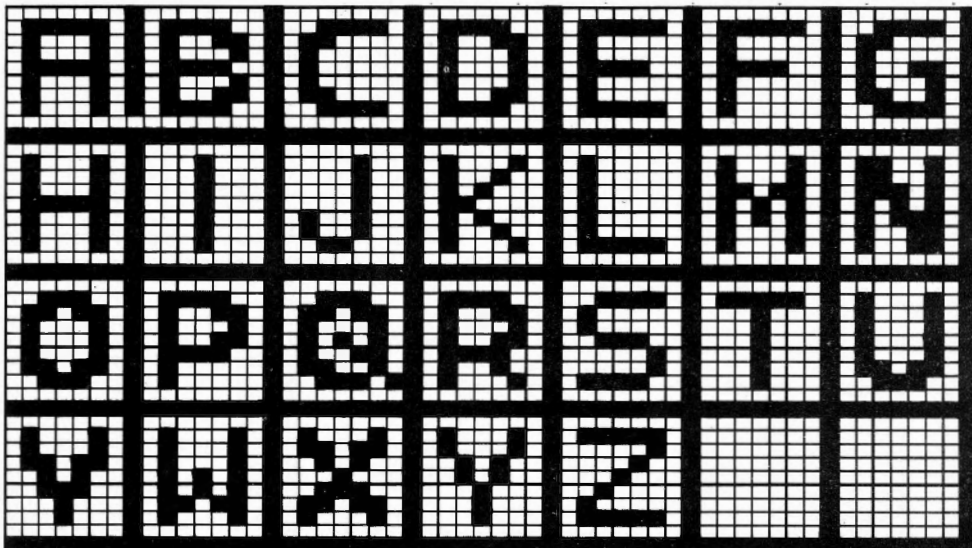

RAGLAN SWEATER IN CABLE/LACE

MACHINES: A, C, F or G with KR. **MATERIALS:** ARGYLL WOOLS Ferndale on Cone; M - 315 (330, 345, 360, 375, 390) g (Shade Moss 406) (85% Courtele, 15% wool, 495 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** Cable/lace patt - 40 sts = 13.3 cm and 60 rows = 15.8 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 2 \times 2 T2/2. **NOTES:** This card was taken from Brother "Punch Card Pattern Vol 3" which contains a large selection of lace cards. To work Cable/Lace patt: on every patt repeat, except where the cable may become part of the seams, trans sts on Ns marked "X" on card/Myler sheet to adjacent N. *Knit 5 rows, push Ns marked "X" into WP, knit 1 row, release yarn caught in Ns marked "X" and return them to NWP position, cable 3 over 3*. Rep from * to * throughout. Work L-Carr movements





before making the cable. Make cable then pull out cable Ns to HP but set K-Carr to NL. Knit 2 rows then cont in patt.

BACK

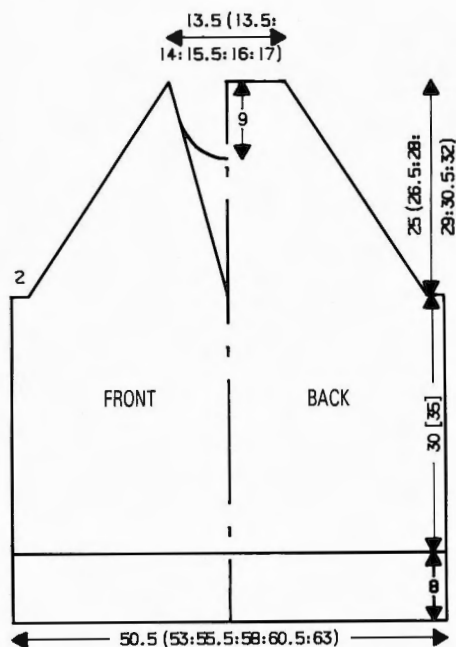
Insert card/sheet and set for first patt row. Cast on 152 (158, 166, 174, 182, 190) sts as RIB and knit 32 rows. Trans to KH, 000. COL T7. Begin with 2 rows with K-Carr, work in cable/lace patt to RC114, COR.

Raglan shaping

*000. Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each of next 2 (2, 4, 4, 3, 3) rows. **Dec 1 st at each end of every foll alt row \times 10, then 1 st at each end of next row**. Cont repeating this 21 row sequence from ** to ** until *40 (40, 42, 46, 48, 50) sts rem. Knit to RC96 (102, 106, 110, 116, 122) and waste knit.

FRONT

As BACK to beg of raglan shaping, 000. Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next 0 (0, 2, 2, 1, 1) rows. Knit 2 rows. Repeat sequence from ** to ** as BACK to RC96 (102, 106, 110, 116, 122) and AT THE SAME TIME, at RC62 (68, 72, 76, 82, 88) note sheet/card position and waste knit centre 12 (12, 14, 14, 14, 16) sts.



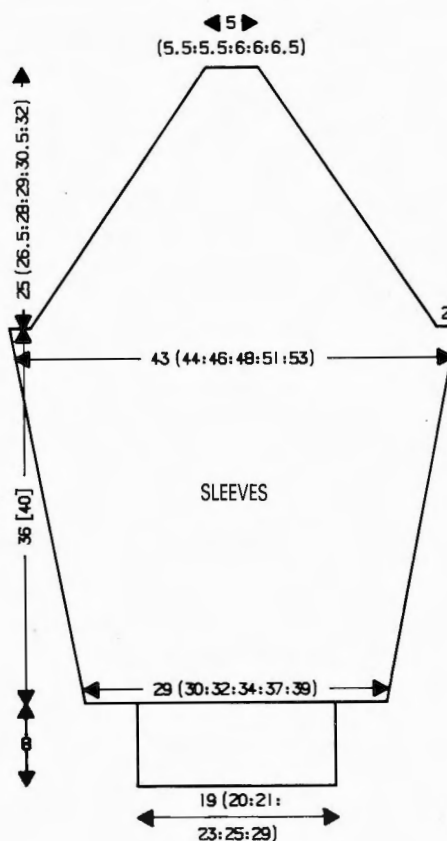
Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row, at beg of next and every foll alt row cast off 4 sts \times 1, 3 sts \times 1, 2 sts \times 2 and 1 st \times 3. Reset card/sheet. Return sts at left to Ns and knit to match right side reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Insert card/sheet and set for first patt row. Using WY cast on 86 (92, 98, 102, 110, 118) sts and knit a few rows ending with COL, 000. T7 change to M and work in Cable/Lace patt, starting with 2 rows with K-Carr to RC136, and AT THE SAME TIME inc 1 st at each end of every 6th row \times 21 [128 (134, 140, 144, 152, 160) sts].

Raglan shaping

As BACK from * to * until 16 (16, 16, 16, 18,



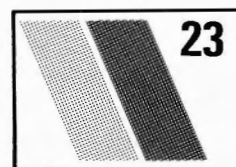
20) sts rem. Knit to RC96 (102, 106, 110, 116, 122) and waste knit. *Cuffs:* Push 58 (58, 62, 70, 74, 76) Ns into WP. Replace sts from cuff edge onto these Ns distributing them evenly along the row, 000. Using MT7 knit 1 row. Trans to rib T2/2 and knit 31 rows, T10/8, knit 1 row, trans sts to KH and latch off.

NECKBAND

Join three of the raglan seams leaving a back seam open. With right side facing, pick up approx 130 (130, 134, 142, 146, 150) sts evenly along neck edge, including sts on WY. Using M T7 knit 1 row. Trans to rib, 000. Knit 28 rows in RIB. Trans to KH, T7 knit 2 rows and waste knit.

MAKE-UP

Join 4th raglan seam and neckband seam. Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Join side and sleeve seams.



LACE COLLARS

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** ATKINSON MAIL ORDER YARNS: Cannele; White (100% cotton, 410 m/100 g). **NOTES:** The collars may be attached to the garment or cast off at the neck edge and worn as a separate item. The number of sts given is an example only. *Collar attached to garment:* Trans to circular knitting, 000. T5/5, knit to RC8 and waste knit. Attach to neck edge of garment by backstitching through last row knitted in M - first on the outside then on the inside. *Collar as separate item:* Knit a further 3 rows. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

A - Collar shown with Pattern No 22 (Left)

Patt is in multiples of 3. *Push required No of Ns into WP on KH (our example has 162 Ns) and 1 less N on KR, Pitch H. Using M T2/2 knit 1 row. Insert comb and hang weights. T5/5 knit 1 row*. **Within each group of 3 sts trans the two outside sts to centre N leaving empty Ns in WP. Dec tension by $\frac{2}{3}$, knit 4 rows**. Rep from ** to ** \times 4**. Dec 1 st. Trans to 1 \times 1 rib T2/2 and knit 8 rows (see NOTES).

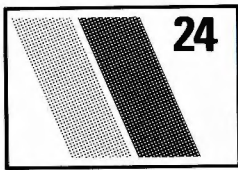

****. Trans to 3 × 4 rib (3 sts on KH and 4 sts on KR - leave end 3 sts on KH), 000. T2/2 knit to RC14. Trans to 1 × 1 rib, knit 8 rows (see NOTES).



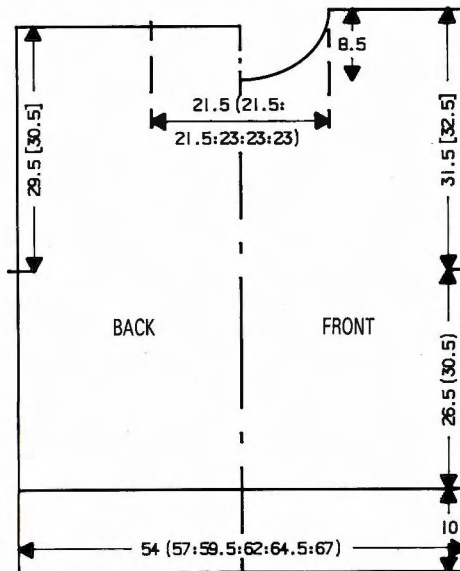
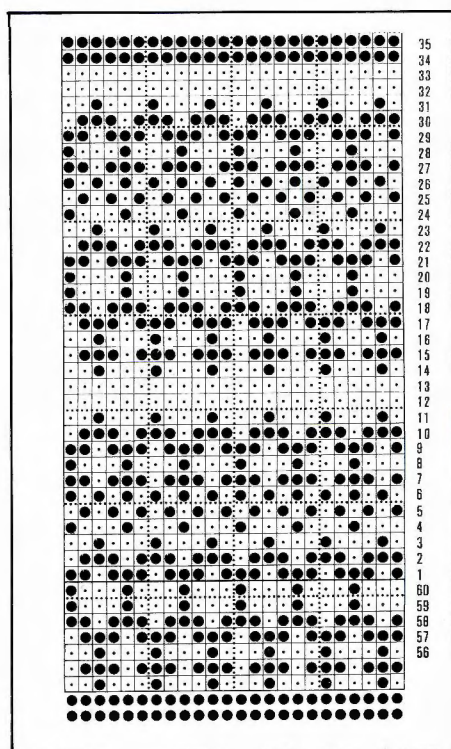

MACHINES: E with KR. **MATERIALS:** ATKINSON MAIL ORDER YARNS Rhapsody; *Lady's size:* M - 420 (440, 460, 480, 500, 520) g (Noir); A - 150 (160, 170, 180, 190, 200) g (Violet), B - 200 (210, 220, 230, 240, 250) g (Pavot). *Man's size:* M - 445 (465, 485, 505, 525, 545) g (Noir), A - 160 (170, 180, 190, 200, 210) g (Savane), B - 215 (225, 235, 245, 255, 265) g (Brique). (18% wool, 67% acrylic, 15% nylon, 160 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust/chest 86 (91, 96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle patt - 20 sts = 13 cm and 30 rows = 15.7 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T1/1. Slide Lever II. **NOTES:** Men's lengths are shown in brackets []. Fairisle colour sequence:

BACK

to KC, knit 1 row, COR, 000. Release card and work in fairisle (see NOTES) to RC50 [58]. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Knit to RC106 [116]. Waste knit centre 33 (33, 33, 35, 35, 35) sts. Waste knit the rem 25 (27, 29, 30, 32, 34) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

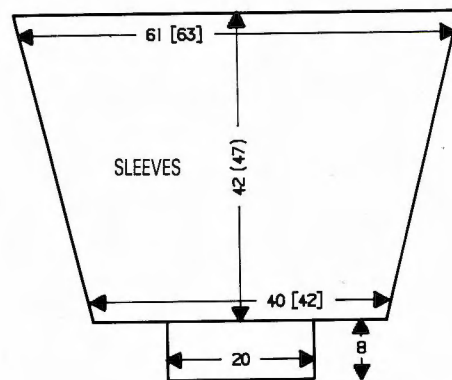
As back to RC94 [104] (Lock card and note position).

Neck shaping

Place all but centre 7 Ns into HP. Waste knit centre 7 sts. Waste knit sts at left, COL. Return Ns at right to WP. Set K-Carr to KC depress both PART Buttons and knit 1 row. Release card and cont in fairisle patt, and AT THE SAME TIME at beg of next and foll alt rows cast off 4 sts × 1, 3 sts × 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2), 2 sts × 2 (2, 2, 1, 1, 1) and 1 st × 2, - 25 (27, 29, 30, 32, 34) sts rem. Knit to RC110 [120] and waste knit. Replace sts at left back onto Ns, (reset RC and card). Knit to match right side reversing shapings.

COLLAR

Join one shoulder by placing one set of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and backstitch cast off. Using M cast on 85 (85, 85, 89, 89, 89) sts as RIB, Side lever I, 000. Knit 10 rows, T $\frac{3}{2}$ / $\frac{2}{3}$ knit 10 rows, T $\frac{1}{3}$ / $\frac{1}{3}$ knit 10 rows, slide lever II, T3/3, knit 30 rows (RC60). Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, pick up sts around neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row and backstitch cast off. Join second shoulder as first.

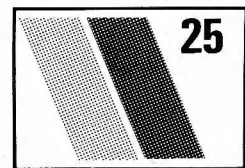


SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Using WY cast on 61 [65] sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. Set K-Carr to KC depress both PART buttons and knit 1 row, 000. T7 with M in FA and A in FB release card and work in fairisle (see NOTES) to RC4 [5]. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 4th [5th] row × 16 - 93 [97] sts. Knit to RC80 [90] and waste knit. Turn work and replace last patt row back onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up sts along armhole edge between markers and place onto same Ns. T10 knit 1 row and backstitch cast off. *Cuffs:* Using M cast on 41 [43] sts as RIB and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side of sleeve facing replace sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and backstitch cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join side, sleeve and collar seams.



CLASSIC DRESS

MACHINES: D and E with KR. **MATERIALS:** PHILDAR Poilé Flammé; M - 950 (975, 1000, 1025, 1050) g (Laser 52) (37% cotton, 32% polyester, 16% acrylic, 6% wool, 6% polyamide, 3% kid mohair, 142 m/100 g). Belt. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 20 sts = 15 cm and 30 rows = 15.5 cm (approx T10). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T1/1 Slide Lever I. **NOTES:** Use diagram from Patt no 2 changing measurement from top of waist rib to underarm to 14.5 cm.

FRONT

Using M cast on 87 (93, 97, 101, 107) sts as RIB and knit to RC174. Waste knit. Push 70 (74, 77, 80, 84) Ns into WP. Place sts onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row, 000. T10 knit to RC28. 000. Place a WY marker at each end of work*. Knit to RC36. **Place centre 12 Ns into HP. Place all Ns at left into HP, 000. Knit 2 rows. Place into HP, before knitting next and every foll alt row** 3 sts × 4. Knit to RC24. ***Waste knit rem 17 (19, 21, 22, 24) sts. Leaving centre 12 Ns and Ns to right in HP. Return Ns at left to WP and knit to match right side reversing shapings. Waste knit all rem sts***.

BACK

As FRONT to *. Knit to RC44. As FRONT from ** to ** 4 sts × 3. Knit to RC12 and work as FRONT from *** to ***. Join shoulder by placing one set of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. Knit 1 row and cast off. *Collar:* Using WY cast on 111 sts and knit a few rows. Change to M T10 and knit 3 rows. With wrong side facing pick up 111 sts along neck edge and place onto Ns. T10 knit 1 row. Trans to rib. T4/4 knit 10 rows. T3/3 knit 10 rows. T2/2 knit 10 rows, T1/1 knit 10 rows. T10/10 knit 1

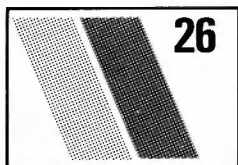
row. Trans to KH and latch off. Join second shoulder as first.

SLEEVES

With wrong side facing pick up 80 sts along armhole edge between WY markers and place onto Ns, 000. T10 knit to RC6. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 5th row \times 14. Knit to RC82 and waste knit. *Cuffs:* Using M cast on 39 sts as RIB and knit 20 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge onto Ns distributing sts evenly along the row. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join collar, side and sleeve seams. Backstitch first row of collar to garment. Give skirt a light press. Make belt loops.



LADY'S/MAN'S ENGLISH RIB SWEATER

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** KING COLE Anti-Tickle Wool, 4-ply; *LADY'S:* M - 600 (620, 640, 660, 680, 700) g (shade 163), *MAN'S:* M - 720 (750, 790, 830, 870, 900) g. (100% wool, 380 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit chest/bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106, 111) cm. **TENSION:** English rib - 40 sts = 13.3 cm and 60 rows = 8.9 cm (approx T3/3). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T2/2. **NOTES:** Man's lengths given in square brackets []. For diagram see Patt No 22.

BACK

Using M cast on 151 (157, 165, 173, 181, 189) sts as RIB and knit 32 rows. 000. Set for English rib (see KR instruction book) T3/3, knit to RC202 [234], *000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 6 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st fully-fashioned (2 sts in from edge) at each end of next and every foll 3rd row \times 32 (34, 36, 38, 40, 42) then each end of every foll 4th row \times 18 (19, 20, 20, 21, 22)*, - 39 (39, 41, 45, 47, 49) sts. Knit to RC168 (178, 188, 194, 204, 214) and waste knit.

FRONT

As back to RC108 (118, 128, 134, 144, 154) above raglan shaping. Work raglan shaping as BACK and AT THE SAME TIME waste knit centre 11 (11, 13, 13, 13, 15) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and every foll 4th row cast off 4 sts \times 1, 3 sts \times 1 (1, 1, 2, 2, 2), 2 sts \times 2 and 1 st \times 3 (3, 3, 2, 3, 3). Knit to RC168 (178, 188, 194, 204, 214). Return sts at left to Ns and knit to match right side reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using WY cast on 85 (91, 97, 101, 109, 117) sts as RIB and knit a few rows ending with COR. 000. Set for English rib (see KR instruction book) T3/3 knit to RC240

[268], and AT THE SAME TIME at RC4 [8] inc 1 st at each end of next and every 10th row \times 21 [12th row \times 21], - 127 (133, 139, 143, 151, 159) sts.

Raglan shaping

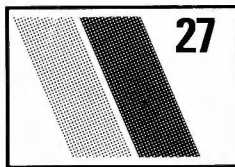
Work as BACK from * to *, - 15 (15, 15, 15, 17, 19) sts rem. Knit to RC168 (178, 188, 194, 204, 214) and waste knit. *Cuffs:* Push 57 (59, 63, 69, 75, 77) Ns into WP. Replace sts from cuff edge onto these Ns, distributing them evenly along the row. 000. Using M T7 knit 1 row. Trans to rib T2/2 and knit 31 rows. T10/8, knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

NECKBAND

Join three of the raglan seams leaving a back seam open. With right side facing, pick up approx 129 (137, 145, 153, 161, 169) sts evenly along neck edge including sts on WY. Using M T7, knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, 000. Knit 28 rows. Trans to KH, T7, knit 2 rows, waste knit.

MAKE-UP

Join 4th raglan seam and neckband seam. Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Join side and sleeve seams. Turn cuffs to inside and slip stitch into position.



POLO NECK CLASSIC DRESS

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** ATKINSON MAIL ORDER YARNS - 4-ply Forsell; M - 800 (850, 900, 950, 1000) g (Silver Grey) (100% pure wool, 380 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Flat Rib (Pitch H - all Ns on KH in WP, 2 \times 2 Ns on KR in WP. When shaping count Ns on KH only), 40 sts = 12.7 cm and 60 rows = 15.2 cm (approx T6/4). **RIB:** Collar and Cuffs: 2 \times 2 Pitch P. (approx T4/4). **NOTES:** For diagram see patt no 11.

BACK

Using M cast on 159 (167, 175, 183, 191) sts as FNR. Trans for Flat Rib (see TENSION) working from centre outwards, 000. T5/3 knit to RC40, 000. T6/4 knit to RC210, 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row \times 44 (46, 48, 50, 52), then every row \times 12. Knit to RC102 (106, 110, 114, 118) and waste knit rem 39 (43, 47, 51, 55) sts.

FRONT

As BACK to RC82 (86, 90, 94, 98) above beg of raglan shaping.

Neck shaping

Cont raglan shaping as BACK and, AT THE SAME TIME, waste knit centre 11

(15, 17, 21, 23) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 3 sts \times 1, 2 sts \times 2 and 1 st \times 5. Knit to RC102 (106, 110, 114, 118) and bind off rem 2 (2, 3, 3, 4) sts. Replace sts at left and knit to match right side reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using M cast on 88 (88, 93, 93, 98) sts as RIB and knit 50 rows. Trans for Flat Rib making sts as necessary (see TENSION) working from centre outwards, 000. T6/4 knit 4 rows. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 8th row \times 16 (18, 17, 18, 17). [120 (124, 127, 129, 132) sts] Knit to RC150, 000.

Raglan shaping

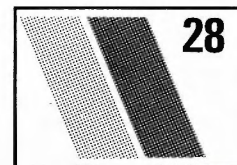
Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit 1 row. Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 3rd row \times 4 (4, 6, 6, 8), then every alt row \times 44 (46, 45, 46, 46). Knit to RC102 (106, 110, 114, 118). Waste knit rem 16 (16, 17, 17, 16) sts.

POLO COLLAR

Join 3 raglan seams leaving one back seam open. Using M cast on 134 (138, 142, 146, 150) sts as RIB and knit 120 rows. Trans to KH. With right side facing, replace sts from around neck edge back onto Ns. T6 knit 3 rows and waste knit.

MAKE-UP

Join raglan and collar seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Backstitch through last row of st of collar.



INTARSIA CARDIGAN

MACHINES: D or E with Intarsia Carriage + KL and KR. **MATERIALS:** PINGOUIN Pingofine; M - 190 (200, 210) g (Cendres 312) (75% acrylic, 25% wool, 200 m/100 g). PINGOUIN Intrigue; A and B - 350 (400, 450) g (Blanc casse 01 and Gris 02 respectively), (25% wool, 15% mohair, 42% polyamide, 18% acrylic, 182 m/100 g). Buttons as required. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit bust 86/91 (96/101, 106/111) cm. **TENSION:** Intarsia/st st (when making your tension swatch use Intarsia Carriage if you intend to work garment with the Intarsia Carriage - Intarsia Carriage and K-Carr tensions can be very different) - 20 sts = 13.3 cm and 30 rows = 12.5 cm (approx T5). **RIB:** Using 2 ends of M throughout, 1 \times 1 T0/0 - button and buttonhole bands T1/1. **NOTES:** Use diagram from patt no 4 and draw onto KL sheet in half scale to required size. It is usual with D or E machines to work the tension swatch over 20 sts and 30 rows, however when working in half scale measure across 40 sts and 30 rows and use the Stitch Scale from KL set to correspond (not from machine set). SET KL TO TRIP ONCE EVERY ROW

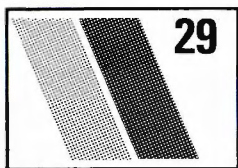

Work tension swatch. Draw garment

diagram onto KL sheet in half scale. Draw in chevron design. Select Stitch Scale and set KL for rows. Beg with BACK. Cast on required no of sts as RIB and knit 24 rows. Trans to KH and cont in intarsia patt remembering to place WY markers for underarm. Waste knit BACK neck and shoulder sts. Next work FRONTS. Cast on required no of sts as RIB and knit 24 rows. Trans to KH and cont in intarsia patt remembering to place WY markers for underarm. Cast off for neck edge shaping and waste knit shoulders. Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts onto Ns with right sides together. T10 knit 1 row and cast off. Draw SLEEVES diagram onto KL sheet - top of sleeve to base line. With wrong side facing pick up required number of sts along armhole edge between WY markers. Complete SLEEVES then waste knit. **Cuffs:** Push 53 Ns on KH into WP. With wrong side facing place sts from cuff edge back onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row. Using 2 ends of M T10 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB, and knit 35 rows. T10/8 knit 1 row, trans to KH and latch off. **Buttonband:** Using 2 ends of M cast on required number of sts as RIB, 000. Knit to RC15. Place a WY marker at each end of work. Knit to RC30. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing, pick up sts along left front edge and place onto same Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. **Buttonhole band:** Work as Buttonband making buttonholes at RC15. **Collar:** Using 2 ends of M cast on 109 sts as RIB, T1 $\frac{1}{3}$ /1 $\frac{1}{3}$ knit 6 rows, T1/1 knit 6 rows, T $\frac{2}{3}$ / $\frac{2}{3}$ knit 6 rows, T $\frac{1}{3}$ / $\frac{1}{3}$ knit 6 rows. T0/0 knit 10 rows. Trans to KH. With wrong side facing pick up sts along neck edge between WY markers including sts on WY. Place onto same Ns. T9 knit 1 row and latch off.

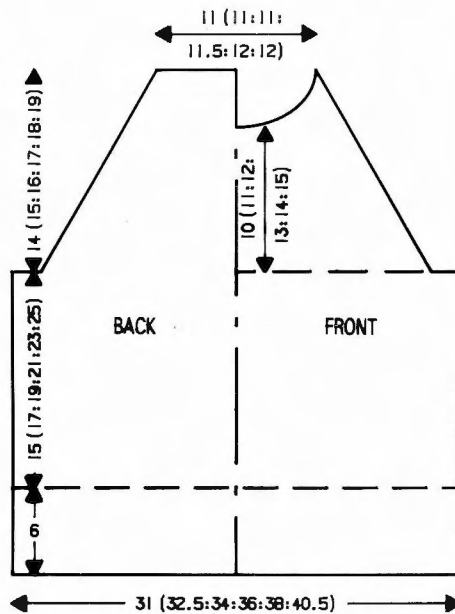

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** KING COLE Superspun Superwash 4-ply - M - 245 (260, 280, 325, 375, 425) g (46 Aran) (100% wool, 380 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 100 (110, 120, 130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** English rib - 40 sts = 13.4 cm and 60 rows = 8.5 cm (when slightly stretched), (approx T3/3). **RIB:** 1 x 1 T0/0. **NOTES:** Raglan shaping - dec 2 sts at each end on KH *using a 3 x 1 trans tool, move the two outside sts one N towards centre*, rep from * to * on KR. Sleeve shaping - inc 2 sts at each end on KH **using a 3 x 1 trans tool, move the two outside sts one place away from centre**, rep from ** to ** on KR, pick up loops from previous row and place on the empty N.



BACK

Using M cast on 93 (97, 101, 107, 113, 121) sts as RIB and knit 30 rows, 000. T3/3 set for English rib and knit 106 (120, 134, 148, 162, 176) rows, 000.

Raglan shaping

Cast off 2 (2, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC8. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 8th row x 10 (11, 12, 13, 14, 14). Knit 2 (2, 4, 4, 4, 4) rows. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 4th row x 4 (4, 3, 3, 3, 5). Knit to RC98 (106, 112, 120, 126, 134) and waste knit rem 33 (33, 33, 35, 37, 37) sts.

FRONT

As BACK to RC70 (78, 84, 92, 98, 106) above raglan shaping. Cont raglan decs and, AT THE SAME TIME ...

Neck shaping

Waste knit centre 11 (11, 11, 11, 13, 13) sts. Waste knit sts at left, COR. Working raglan decs as given, knit 1 row. At beg of next and alt rows cast off 2 sts x 2, then dec 1 st x 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6). Knit to RC98 (106, 112, 120, 126, 134). Cast off rem 2 sts. Replace sts at left onto Ns and knit to match right side reversing shapings.

SLEEVES

Using M cast on 53 (53, 53, 57, 57, 61) sts as RIB and knit 30 rows. 000. T3/3 set for English rib, knit 24 rows. Inc 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 24th row x 5 (6, 7, 7, 8, 8), [73 (77, 81, 85, 89, 93) sts]. Knit to RC148 (162, 176, 190, 210, 232), 000.

Raglan shaping

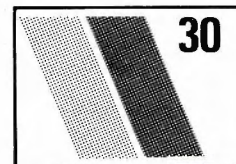
Cast off 2 (2, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC8. Dec 2 sts at each end of next and every foll 8th row x 12 (13, 13, 14, 15, 16). Knit to RC98 (106, 112, 120, 126, 134). Waste knit rem 21 sts.

NECKBAND

Join 3 raglan seams leaving 1 back raglan open. With right side facing, pick up 127 (127, 129, 131, 135, 135) sts evenly along neck edge. T6 knit 1 row. Trans to rib and knit 26 rows. Trans to KH T6 knit 2 rows and waste knit.

MAKE-UP

Join rem raglan and neckband seam. Join side and sleeve seams. Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M.



BALAKLAVA, LEGGINGS AND SCARF

MACHINES: A, B, C, F and G with KR. **MATERIALS:** ATKINSON MAIL ORDER YARNS: 4-ply Forsell; M - Balaklava - 75g, Leggings - 575 g, Scarf - approx. 180 g. (100% wool, 380 m/100 g). Elastic. **MEASUREMENTS:** One size fits from 91 to 111 cm hips. **TENSION:** 2 x 2 Pitch H (see needle arrangement), 40 sts = 9.1 cm and 60 rows = 14.2 cm (approx T4/4). **NOTES:** Count Ns on KH as sts throughout. Work fully-fashioned shaping as folls:

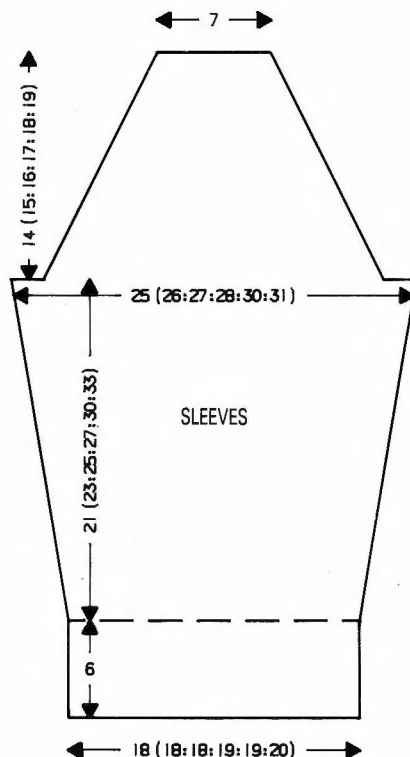
To dec 3 sts at each end of work:



Move sts marked * onto Ns marked **, then move end sts inwards to close the space.

BALAKLAVA

Using M cast on over 131 Ns as rib (see NOTES), 000. T4/4 knit to RC76. Place a



WY marker at each end of work. Dec 3 sts (see NOTES) at each end of next and every foll 6th row \times 6 (work is now over 95 Ns). Knit to RC172. Cast off over 27 Ns at beg of next 2 rows (work is now over 41 Ns). Knit to RC198 and cast off. **Band:** Using M cast on over 14 Ns (see NOTES) and knit to approx RC232 and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join front opening to WY markers. Join seams on crown. Join band into a circle and attach to front opening as illustrated.

LEGGINGS

Using M COBH 200 sts, COR. T5 working in st st knit 12 rows, T10 knit 1 row, T5 knit 11 rows. Trans to 2×2 rib Pitch H (see NOTES) making sts as necessary, 000. T4/4 knit 1 row (when working second leg knit 2 rows at this point), COL. Do not hang weights. At side opposite to K-Carr push work over 100 Ns into HP. Knit 2 rows. On next and alt rows at side opposite to K-Carr push into WP work over 15 Ns \times 6. Knit 1 row over all Ns. Now hang weights. Knit to RC126. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000.

Leg shaping

Dec 3 sts (see NOTES) at each end of next and every foll 10th row \times 15. Knit to RC274, COR, 000.

Stirrup shaping

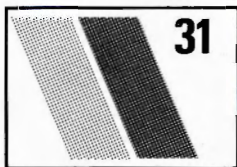
Leave 20 Ns next to K-Carr in WP and push all rem Ns to HP. On side opposite to K-Carr dec 3 sts (see NOTES) on next and every foll 6th row \times 4. Knit to RC26 and cast off. Take back to WP work over next 54 Ns from right to left. Cast off work over 16 Ns at right, 000. Dec 3 sts (see NOTES) at each end of next and every foll 6th row \times 4. Knit to RC26 and cast off. Take back to WP rem work. Cast off work over 16 Ns at right, COR, 000. Dec 3 sts (see NOTES) at each end of next and every foll 6th row \times 4. Knit to RC26 and cast off. Knit second leg to match reversing shapings.

MAKE-UP

Join FRONT and BACK seams. Join leg seams. Fold waistband in half along "fold-line" to inside and stitch into place encasing elastic. Join stirrups with elastic.

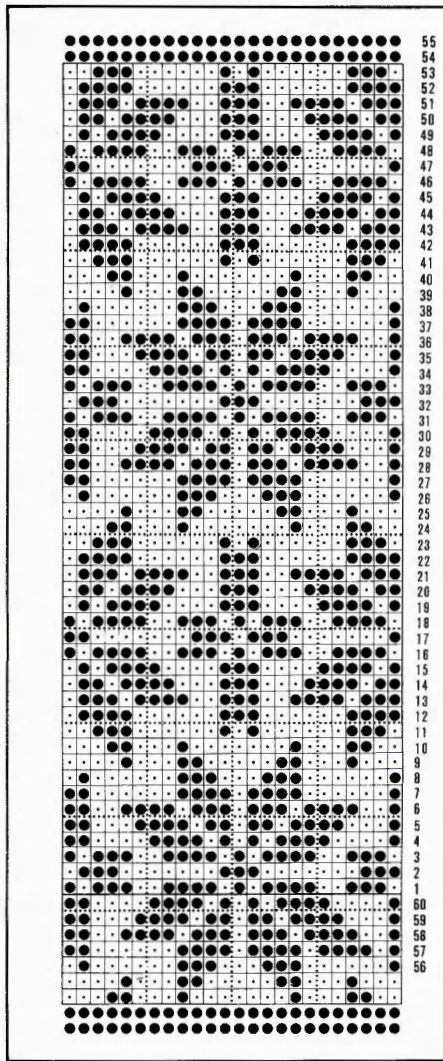

MACHINES: E with KR. **MATERIALS:** JAMIESON and SMITH 2-ply Softspun; M - 465 (475, 485, 495, 505) g (Natural shade no. BSS 16), Con Col - 300 (310, 320, 330, 340) g (Brown shade no. BSS 15), (100% shetland wool, 196 m/100 g). **MEASURE-**



MENTS: To fit bust 86 (91, 96, 101, 106) cm. **TENSION:** Fairisle - 20 sts = 13.3 cm and 30 rows = 14.2 cm (approx T8). **RIB:** *Welts and cuffs* - 1×1 , T2/2 Slide Lever II. *Collar* - 1×1 , work tensions as given in patt instructions. **NOTES:** For diagram see patt no. 2.

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 81 (85, 89, 93, 97) sts as RIB (*Welts and Cuffs*) and knit 35 rows. Trans to KH. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns, 000. T8 with M in FA and Con Col in FB, release card and work in fairisle to RC46. Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC48.

Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Push centre 13 Ns into HP. Push Ns at left into HP, COR. Knit 2 rows. At left, before next and every foll alt row, push into HP 5 Ns \times 1, 4 Ns \times 1, 2 Ns \times 2 and 1 N \times 2. Knit to RC62 and waste knit rem 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts. Return 34 (36, 38, 40, 42) Ns at left to WP, reset card and RC and select Ns to cont patt. Knit to match right side reversing shapings. Waste knit rem 43 sts.

FRONT

As BACK to RC40 above WY markers.

Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Push centre 13 Ns into

HP. Push Ns at left into HP, COR. Knit 2 rows. At left, before next and every foll alt row, push into HP 5 Ns \times 1, 2 Ns \times 2, 1 N \times 5, knit 4 rows, then 1 N \times 1. Knit to RC66 and waste knit rem 19 (21, 23, 25, 27) sts. Return 34 (36, 38, 40, 42) Ns at left to WP, reset card and RC and select Ns to cont patt. Knit to match right side reversing shapings. Waste knit rem 43 sts.

COLLAR

Join left shoulder seam by placing shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together. Using M T10 knit 1 row and latch off. Using WY cast on 101 sts and knit a few rows st st, T7 change to Con Col and knit 2 rows. Pick up same number of sts from around neck edge, including sts on WY and place onto same Ns. Using M T10 knit 1 row. Trans to 1×1 rib, Slide Lever I, T2/2 knit 20 rows. T1 $\frac{2}{3}$ /1 $\frac{2}{3}$ knit 10 rows, T1 $\frac{1}{3}$ /1 $\frac{1}{3}$ knit 10 rows. Slide Lever II, T2/2, knit to RC75, T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off. Backstitch through first row knitted in Con Col. Join right shoulder seam and collar seam.

SLEEVES

Lock card on row 1. Using WY cast on 61 sts and knit a few rows ending with COL. Set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row to select Ns, 000. With M in FA and Con Col in FB release card and work in fairisle to RC88, AT THE SAME TIME, at RC2 inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6th row \times 15 [91 sts]. Waste knit, turn work and replace sts back onto Ns. With wrong side facing pick up sts along armhole edge, between WY markers and place onto same Ns. T10 knit 1 row and latch off. *Cuffs:* Push 40 Ns into WP. With wrong side facing place sts onto Ns distributing them evenly along the row, 000. Using M T7 knit 1 row, trans to rib (*Cuffs*) and knit to RC19. T10/8 knit 1 row. Trans to KH and latch off.

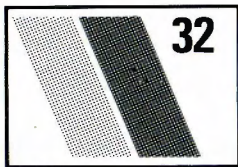

Block and press to shape. Join side and sleeve seams.

HAT

MATERIALS: Allow 80 g of M or Con Col. **MEASUREMENTS:** One size.

Using M or Con Col cast on 91 sts as 1×1 rib. Slide Lever I, 000. T2/2 knit to RC70. *Reduce T by $\frac{1}{3}$, knit 10 rows*. Rep from * to *. Trans to KH. DO NOT BREAK YARN. T5 knit 1 row. Trans every 3rd st to adjacent N [61 sts]. DO NOT BREAK YARN. Waste knit. Push 61 Ns into WP. Replace sts onto Ns. T5 knit 2 rows. Trans alt sts to adjacent Ns [31 sts]. DO NOT BREAK YARN. Waste knit. Push 31 Ns into WP. Replace sts onto Ns. T5 knit 3 rows. Break yarn leaving a length of approx 30 cm. Thread a tapestry needle and pass through sts removing them from their Ns and draw up. Join seam from crown, from the outside for approx 13 cm and then from the inside.



CHILDREN'S CABLE SWEATERS

MACHINES: D or E. **MATERIALS:** SAMBAND Tweed; M 250 (250, 250, 300, 300, 350) g (312 Blue or 319 Red). Allow 50 g extra for Polo Neck version. (100% wool, 200 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height: 100 (110, 120, 130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 20 sts = 13.3 cm and 30 rows = 13 cm (approx T6). **RIB:** 2 x 1, T6-work required number of rows with every 3rd N in NWP and then the horizontal loop is latched up as a purl st. **NOTES:** Cable patts may be worked on either version. *Red Crew Neck version:* The BACK/FRONT is st st with Cable Patt A worked over 14 sts beg with 11 (11, 11, 11, 13, 13)th N each side of '0'. **SLEEVES** are st st with Cable Patt B worked over centre 10 sts. *Blue Polo Neck version:* The BACK/FRONT is st st with Cable Patt C worked over centre 20 sts. **SLEEVES** are st st with Cable Patt D worked over centre 10 sts. Use transfer tools to work cables and then latch up for purl sts every few rows.

BACK

Using WY cast on 50 (50, 52, 56, 60, 64) sts and knit a few rows, 000. T6 change to M and knit to RC40 (40, 48, 50, 58, 62). Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000*. Knit to RC26 (26, 28, 28, 34, 36). Complete all cables and purl sts. Waste knit centre 18 (18, 20, 20, 22, 22) sts. Waste knit rem 16 (16, 16, 18, 19, 21) sts each side for shoulders. *Waist ribs:* Push 50 (50, 52, 56, 60, 64) Ns into WP. With wrong side facing, place sts from waist edge onto Ns. **DO NOT REMOVE WY.** Drop every 3rd st and push empty Ns into NWP, 000. Using M T6 knit to RC15 (15, 15, 15, 21, 21) T10 knit 1 row. Pick up dropped sts and latch up to top of work. Latch off.

FRONT

As BACK to *, knit to RC18 (18, 20, 20, 24, 26). Complete all cables and purl sts.

Neck shaping

Push into HP centre 10 (10, 10, 10, 12, 12) Ns, COR, 000. Push Ns at left to HP, knit 2 rows. At neck edge on next and alt rows, push into HP 2 (2, 3, 3, 3, 3) sts x 1, then 1 st x 2. [16 (16, 16, 18, 19, 21) sts] Knit to RC8 (8, 8, 8, 10, 10) and waste knit. Return Ns at left to WP and knit to match right side reversing shapings. Waste knit rem sts.

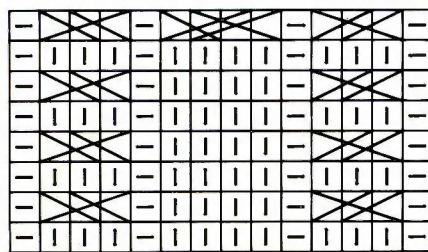

NECKBAND

Using M T10 knit 1 row and backstitch cast off. *Polo version:* Push approx 52 (52, 54, 56, 60, 60) Ns to WP and with right side facing pick up sts around neck edge including sts on WY - **DO NOT REMOVE WY.** Take every 3rd N to NWP allowing loop to drop off N, 000**. T8 using M knit approx 26 (26, 26, 30, 30, 30) rows. T10 knit 1 row. Pick up dropped sts and latch up to top of work. Latch off. Join last shoulder and collar seam. *Crew Neck Version:* As Polo version to **. T6 using M knit 20 rows. Pick up dropped sts and latch up to top of work. Knit 1 row and waste knit. Press. Join shoulder and neckband seams. Fold neckband in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. *Both versions:* Join armhole, side and sleeve seams. Give final press.



GILET

MACHINES: Garter Carriage. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive DK; M - 60 (75, 100, 125) g (Scarlet 6199), A, B and C - 50 (60, 70, 80) g (A - Yellow 6211, B - Fuschia 6213, C - Carribean 6207) (50% acrylic, 25% nylon, 25% wool 300 m/100 g); 1 × 40 (45, 50, 50) cm open end zipper. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 120 (130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** Using Card 2 from Garter Carriage basic set - 40 sts = 17.3 cm and 60 rows = 12.2 cm (approx T9). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T5.

BACK

Set for 1 × 1 rib. Using M COBH 85 (89, 93, 99) sts, 000. T5 working in rib, knit to RC20, 000. Change to Card 2, T9, and cont in patt working in stripes of 12 rows in each of A, B, C and M, knit to RC130 (150, 164, 174), 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 7 sts at beg of next 2 rows, [71 (75, 79, 85) sts rem]. Knit to RC74 (80, 84, 88). Waste knit 22 (24, 26, 29) sts at each end of work for shoulders Waste knit rem 27 sts.

RIGHT FRONT

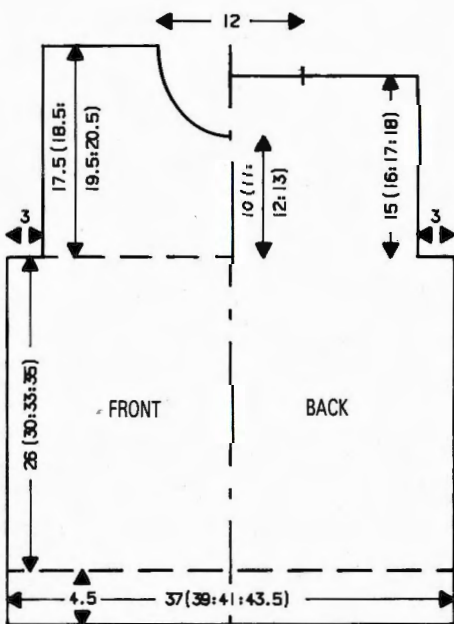
Set for 1 × 1 rib. Using M COBH 43 (45, 47, 50) sts, 000. T5 working in rib, knit to RC20, 000. Change to Card 2. Work to match BACK to RC130 (150, 164, 174), 000.

Armhole shaping

Cast off 7 sts at beg of next row, [36 (38, 40, 43) sts rem]. Knit to RC51 (55, 59, 65), COL.

Neck shaping

At beg of next and alt rows, cast off 5 sts × 1,



2 sts × 2, 1 st × 5, [22 (24, 26, 29) sts rem]. Knit to RC86 (92, 96, 102) and waste knit.

LEFT FRONT

As RIGHT FRONT reversing shapings.

MAKE-UP

Join shoulders by placing both sets of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides together, T10 knit 1 row and cast off. With wrong side facing pick up 83 (87, 92, 97) sts evenly along armhole edge between cast off sts at underarm. Using M T10 knit 1 row. T6 use card for 1 × 1 rib, knit 14 rows and cast off loosely. Join end of trim to cast off edge at underarm. **Neckband:** With wrong side facing pick up 83 (83, 85, 85) sts evenly along neck edge. Using M knit 1 row. Trans to rib T6, knit 2 rows, COR. *Using the Cast-on thread, knit back to NWP 12 sts at opposite side to Carr, knit 1 row*. Rep from * to *. On next and every row on opposite side to Carr bring back to WP 2 Ns until all Ns are in WP. Knit 1 row over all Ns and cast off. Using M work 2 rows of crochet along FRONT edges. Set in zipper. Join side seams.

HAT

MACHINES: Garter Carriage. **MATERIALS:** As GILET - 50 g in each of the 4 colours. **MEASUREMENTS:** One size only. **TENSION:** As GILET

Using M COBH 109 sts. Using K-Carr, T10 knit 24 rows. Change to Garter Carriage, 000. Using Card 2 from Garter Carriage basic set and working in stripe patt to match GILET, knit to RC72. T6 knit 6 rows RIB. Trans every alt st to adjacent N leaving empty Ns in NWP. Using K-Carr T4 knit 6 rows. Thread yarn through sts and pull up.

MAKE-UP

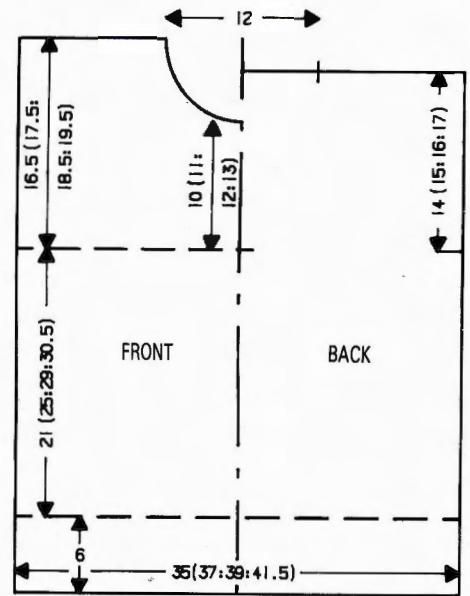

MACHINES: Garter Carriage. **MATERIALS:** PATONS Beehive DK; M - 200 (220, 240, 260) g (Carribean 6207), A - 150 (170, 190, 210) g (Fuschia 6213), B and C - 20 (30, 40, 50) g (B - Scarlet 6196, C - Yellow 6211), (50% acrylic, 25% nylon, 25% wool, 300 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 120 (130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** Card A - 40 sts = 16.5 cm and 60 rows = 12.5 cm (approx T9), Card 2 from Garter Carriage basic set - 40 sts = 17.3 cm and 60 rows = 12.2 cm (approx T9). **RIB:** 1 × 1 T5. **NOTES:** BACK and FRONT are knitted using Card A in stripes of 12 rows M and 12 rows A. Sleeves are knitted using Card 2 from Garter Carriage basic set in stripes of 12 rows in each of M, A, C and B.

BACK

Using M COBH 85 (89, 93, 99) sts, 000. Set for RIB, T5 knit 24 rows, 000. Change to Card A, working in stripes knit to RC100 (120, 140, 146). Mark each end of work with WY, 000*. Knit to RC68 (72, 76, 82). Waste knit 28 (30, 32, 35) sts at each end of work



for shoulders. Waste knit rem 29 sts for neck. Drop the sts marked "x" on Card A to top of rib. Using a latchet tool latch up 2 sts at a time to top of work.

FRONT

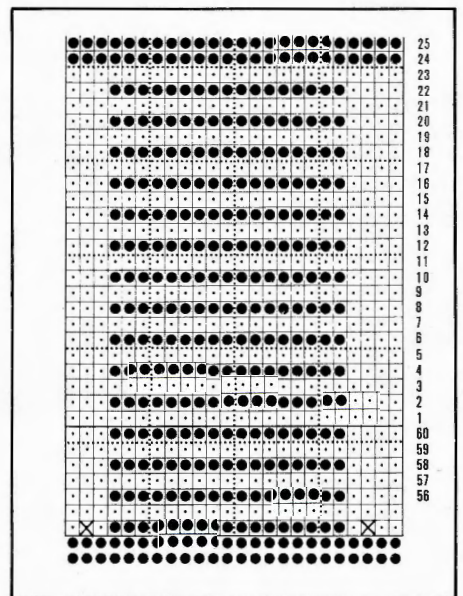
As BACK to *. Knit to RC48 (52, 58, 62), COR.

Neck shaping

Work dropped sts ending at neck edge, AT THE SAME TIME, waste knit centre 11 sts. Waste knit sts at left, knit 1 row, at beg of next and alt rows, cast off 2 sts × 2, then dec 1 st × 5, knit to RC80 (84, 88, 94), work dropped sts, then waste knit. Replace sts from left side back onto Ns, knit to match right side reversing shapings.

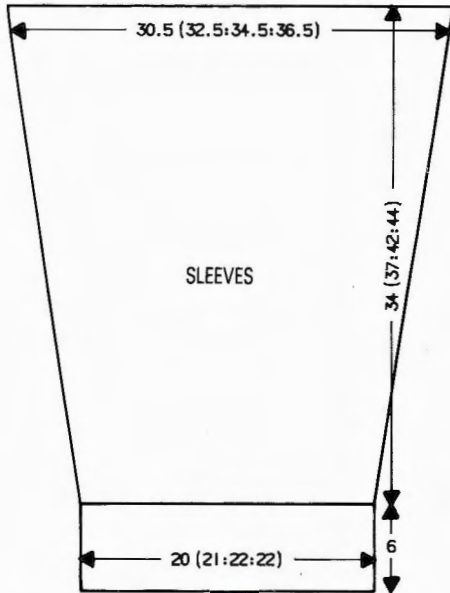

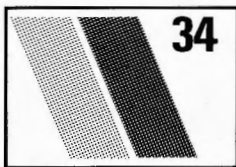

STRIPE AND FAIRISLE SWEATER

MACHINES: E. **MATERIALS:** PHIL-DAR Sagittaire 245; M - 200 (225, 250, 300) g (22 Bouton d'Or), A - 75 (90, 105, 120) g (10 Blanc), B - 20 (30, 40, 50) g (67 Noir), (70% acrylic, 30% wool, 266 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 120 (130, 140, 150) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 20 sts = 10.7 cm and 30 rows = 10 cm (approx T2). Fairisle - 20 sts = 10.7 cm and 30 rows = 11 cm (approx T3). **RIB:** Cast on with every 3rd N in NWP, work required number of rows and then latch up "ladder". **NOTES:** Stripe patt - *knit 16 rows M, knit 4 rows A*, rep from * to * throughout st st section. Garment is knitted in direction shown by arrows on diagram.

SLEEVE

Using WY cast on 44 (48, 52, 56) sts and knit a few rows ending with COR. 000. T2 using M (A, M, M) knit 6 (4, 16, 6) rows, cont in stripe patt (see NOTES) throughout and, AT THE SAME TIME, knit to RC6 (7,

8, 8) and inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6 (7, 8, 8)th row \times 15 [74 (78, 82, 86) sts]. Knit to RC102 (114, 126, 132), waste knit but DO NOT BREAK YARN.

BACK

COR. Replace 5 (7, 9, 11) sts at right edge of work back onto Ns. Cast on 37 (44, 46, 54) sts at beg of row, 000. Knit to RC112 (116, 124, 132), COR. Cast off 37 (44, 46, 54) sts at beg of row. Waste knit rem sts.

FRONT

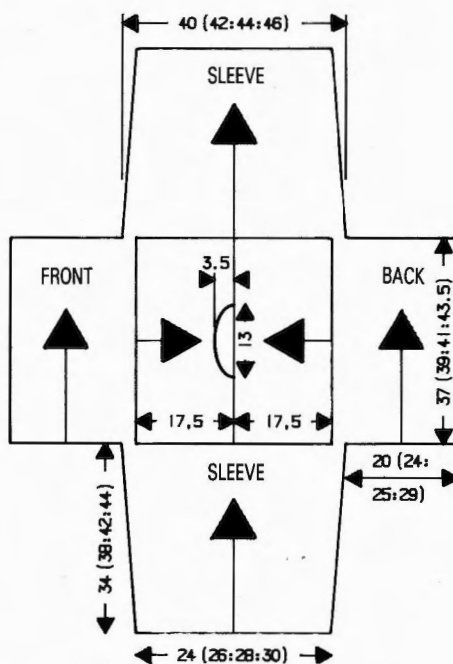
COL. Replace 5 (7, 9, 11) sts at left side of top of sleeve back onto Ns and cast on 37 (44, 46, 54) sts at beg of row, 000. Cont in stripe patt, knit to RC112 (116, 124, 132). Cast off 37 (44, 46, 54) sts at beg of row. Waste knit rem sts.

SLEEVE

Using WY cast on 64 sts and knit a few rows. At each side of waste knitting replace 5 (7, 9, 11) sts from FRONT and BACK [74 (78, 82, 86) sts], 000. Working in stripe patt knit to RC12 (9, 6, 12), dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 6 (7, 8, 8)th row \times 15. Knit to RC102 (114, 126, 132) and waste knit.

BACK YOKE

Insert card and lock on row 1. With wrong side facing, pick up 68 (72, 76, 80) sts evenly along top of BACK. With A in FA and B in FB, 000. T3 release card and work in fairisle, cast on 1 st at beg of next 2 rows. Knit to RC36**. T2 with A only work in st st to RC48. Waste knit centre 24 sts. Waste knit rem 23 (25, 27, 29) sts each side of work for shoulders.

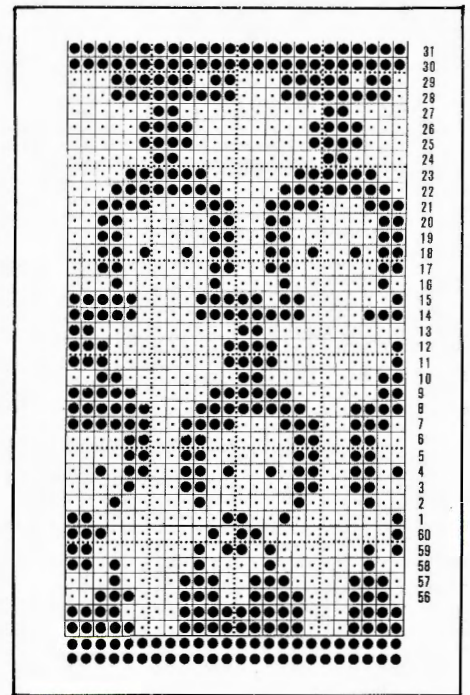

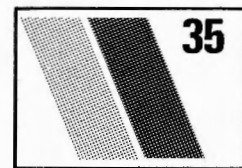

Join rem shoulder as first. Join neckband, fold in half to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M. Backstitch top of sleeve to yoke. Join side and sleeve seams.

MACHINES: A, C, F and G with KR and Single Bed Colour Changer. **MATERIALS:** KING COLE Superspun Superwash 4-ply; M - 200 (220, 240, 260) g (26 Bluebell), A, B and C - small amount in each (A - 118 Wild Rose, B - 10 Amber, and C - 9 Scarlet), (100% wool, 380 m/100 g). **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 100 (110, 120, 130) cm. **TENSION:** Skip st patt - 40 sts = 13.3 cm and 60 rows = 6.5 cm (approx T7). **RIB:** 1 \times 1 T0/0. **NOTES:** Lock card on row 1. Work rib ending with COR, set K-Carr to KC and knit 1 row, release card. Depress both PART buttons and change colours as indicated on card.

BACK

Insert card and lock on row 1. Using M cast on 101 (105, 109, 115) sts as RIB and knit 30 rows, 000. Trans to KH, T7 and knit in skip patt (see NOTES) to RC174 (202, 230, 266). Place a WY marker at each end of work, 000. Knit to RC110 (120, 128, 138). Waste knit centre 39 sts. Waste knit 31 (33, 35, 38) sts each side for shoulders.

FRONT

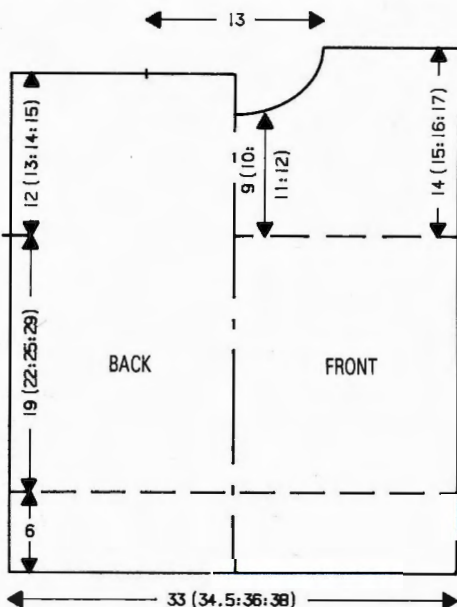
As BACK to RC82 (92, 102, 110) above WY markers.

Neck shaping

(Note card position.) Waste knit centre 13 sts. Waste knit sts at left. Knit 3 rows, COL. At beg of next and every foll 4th row cast off 3 sts \times 1, 2 sts \times 2 and 1 st \times 6. Knit to RC128 (138, 148, 156) and waste knit. Replace sts at left back onto Ns, reset card, knit to match right side reversing shapings.

NECKBAND

Join one shoulder by placing one set of shoulder sts back onto Ns with right sides



together, T10 knit 1 row and cast off. With right side facing, pick up 109 sts evenly along neck edge. T7 knit 1 row. Trans to RIB and knit 30 rows. Trans to KH, T6 knit 2 rows and waste knit. Join second shoulder as first. Join neckband seam then fold to outside and backstitch through last row knitted in M.

SLEEVES

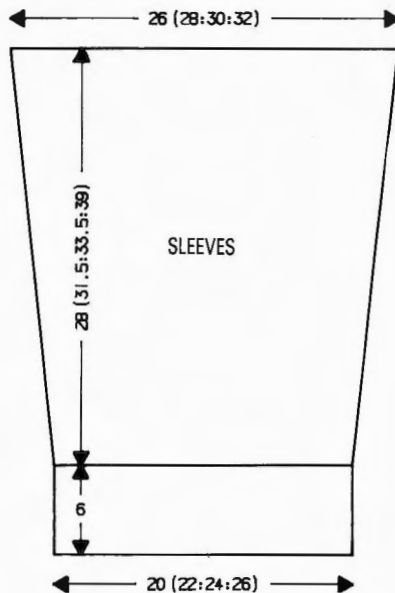
Lock card on row 1. Using M, cast on 61 (67, 73, 79) sts as RIB and knit 30 rows, 000. Trans to KH, T7 and work in skip patt to RC20. Inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll 18th row \times 9. Knit to RC266 (294, 322, 358). Waste knit, turn work and replace sts back onto Ns. Pick up 79 (85, 91, 97) sts evenly along armhole edge between markers and place onto same Ns. T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Block and press. Join side and sleeve seams.

SKIRT

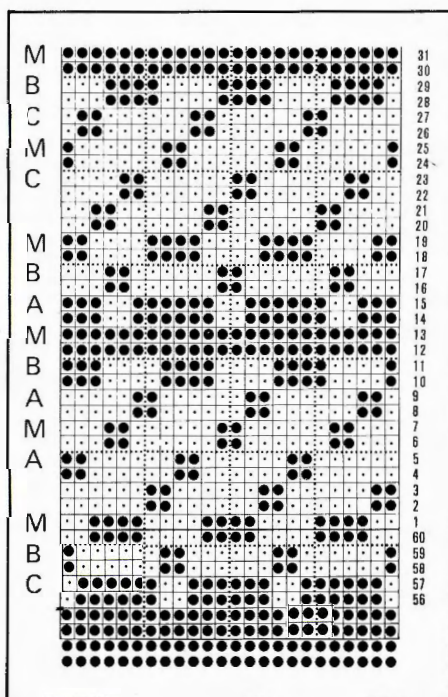
MACHINES: A, C, F and G with Single Bed Colour Changer. **MATERIALS:** KING



M and place onto Ns. T6 knit 1 row. With wrong side facing replace sts from waist edge of MAIN PART back onto Ns - 2 sts to 1 N, T10 knit 1 row and cast off.

MAKE-UP

Join side seam. Thread elastic through waist and join securely. Join waistband seam. Give final press.



COLE Superspun Superwash 4-ply; 50 (60, 70, 80) g in each of the 4 colours as in SWEATER, elastic to fit waist. **MEASUREMENTS:** To fit height 100 (110, 120, 130) cm, approx length 33 (36, 40, 44) cm. **TENSION:** St st - 40 sts = 13 cm and 60 rows = 13.6 cm (approx T5). **NOTES:** Work in stripes of 4 rows in each colour as illustrated.

MAIN PART

(2 pieces.) Using WY cast on 182 (188, 194, 200) sts and knit a few rows, 000. T4 $\frac{3}{4}$ work in stripe patt to RC15. T10 knit 1 row, 000. T5 knit 16 rows. Pick up first row knitted in M and place onto Ns. Work in stripe patt to RC144 (160, 176, 192) and waste knit.

WAISTBAND

Block and press and join one seam. Using WY cast on 182 (188, 194, 200) sts and knit a few rows, 000. T4 $\frac{3}{4}$ change to M and cont in stripes throughout, to RC16. T10 knit 1 row. T4 $\frac{3}{4}$ knit to RC33. Pick up first row knitted in

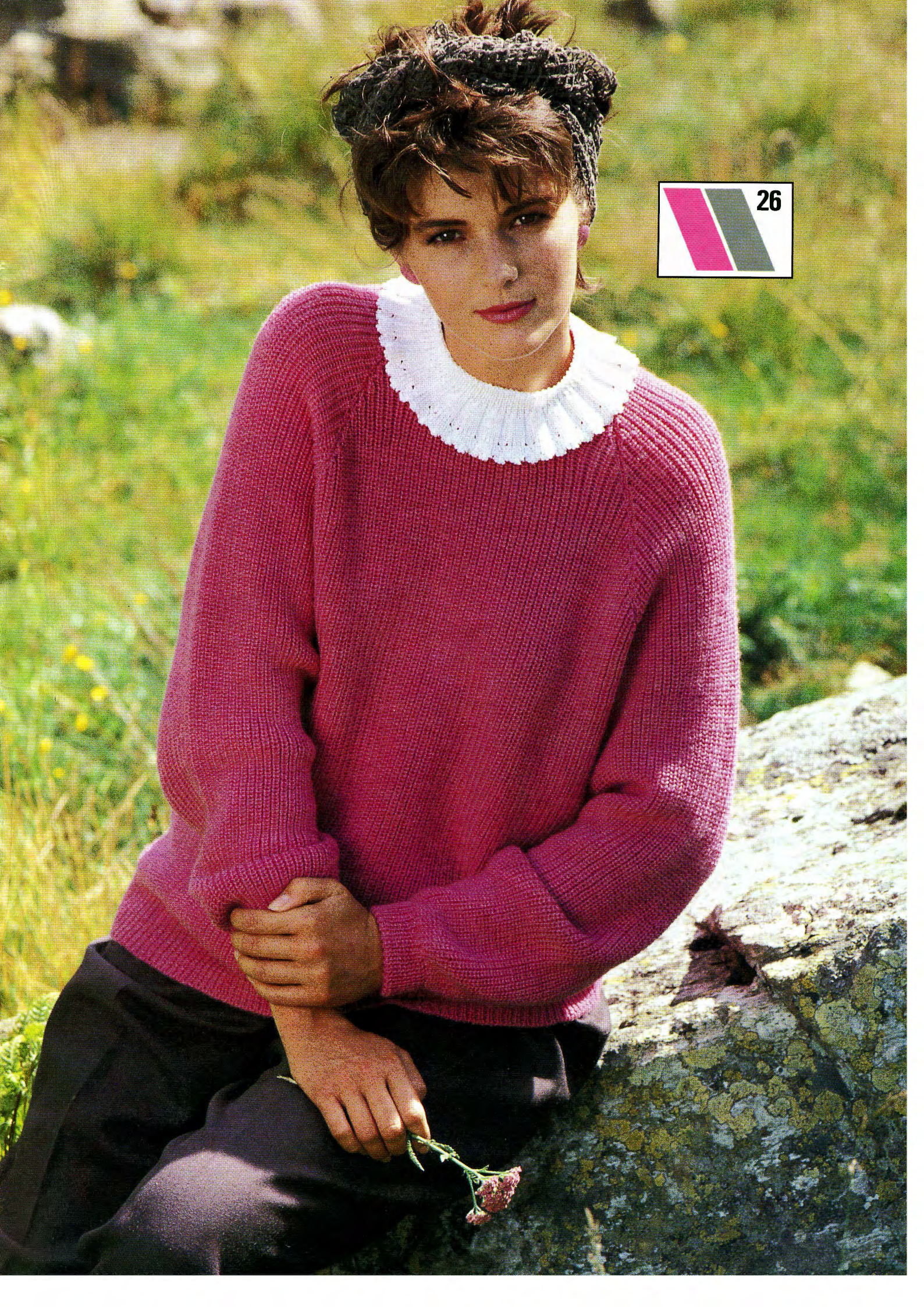








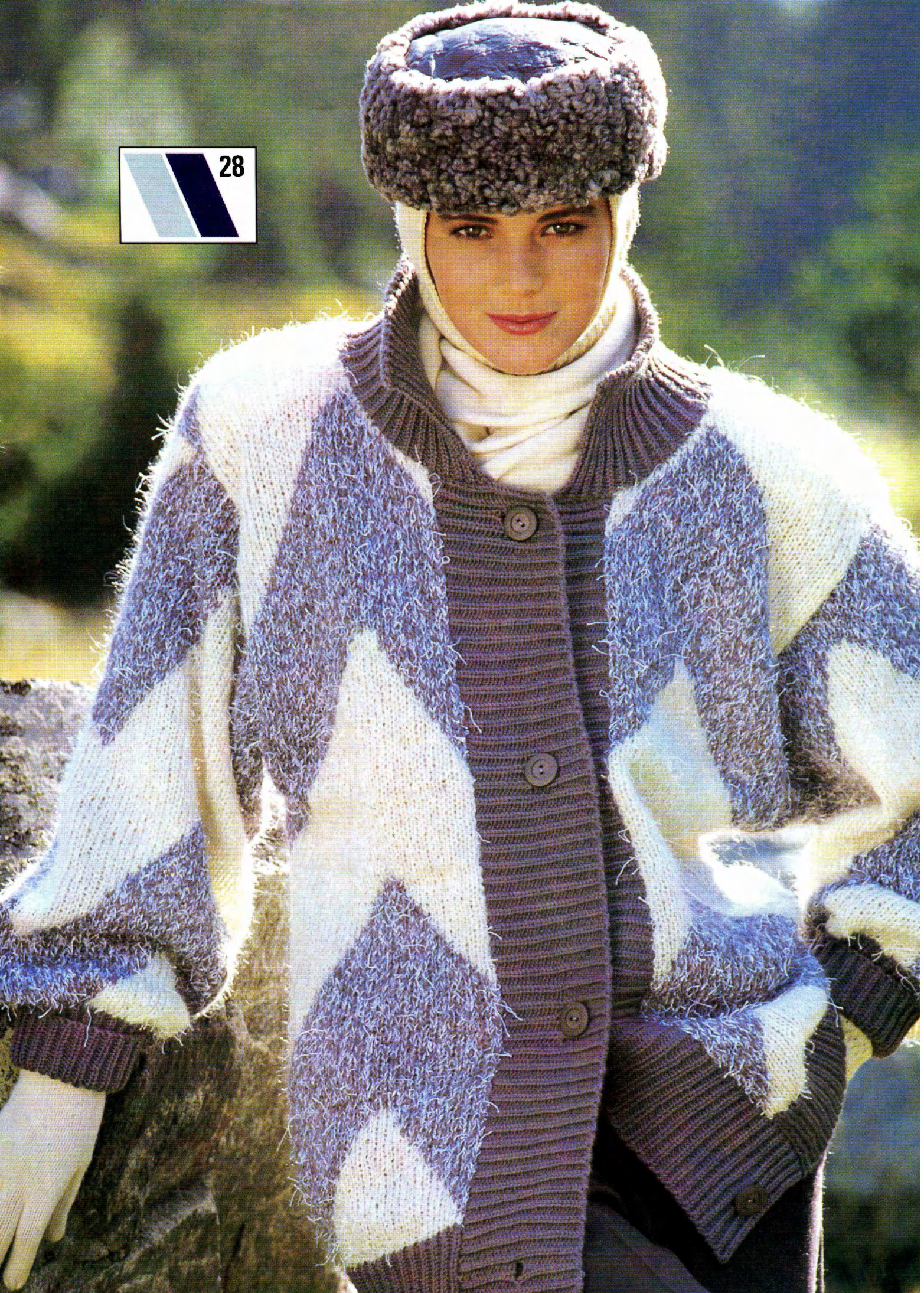
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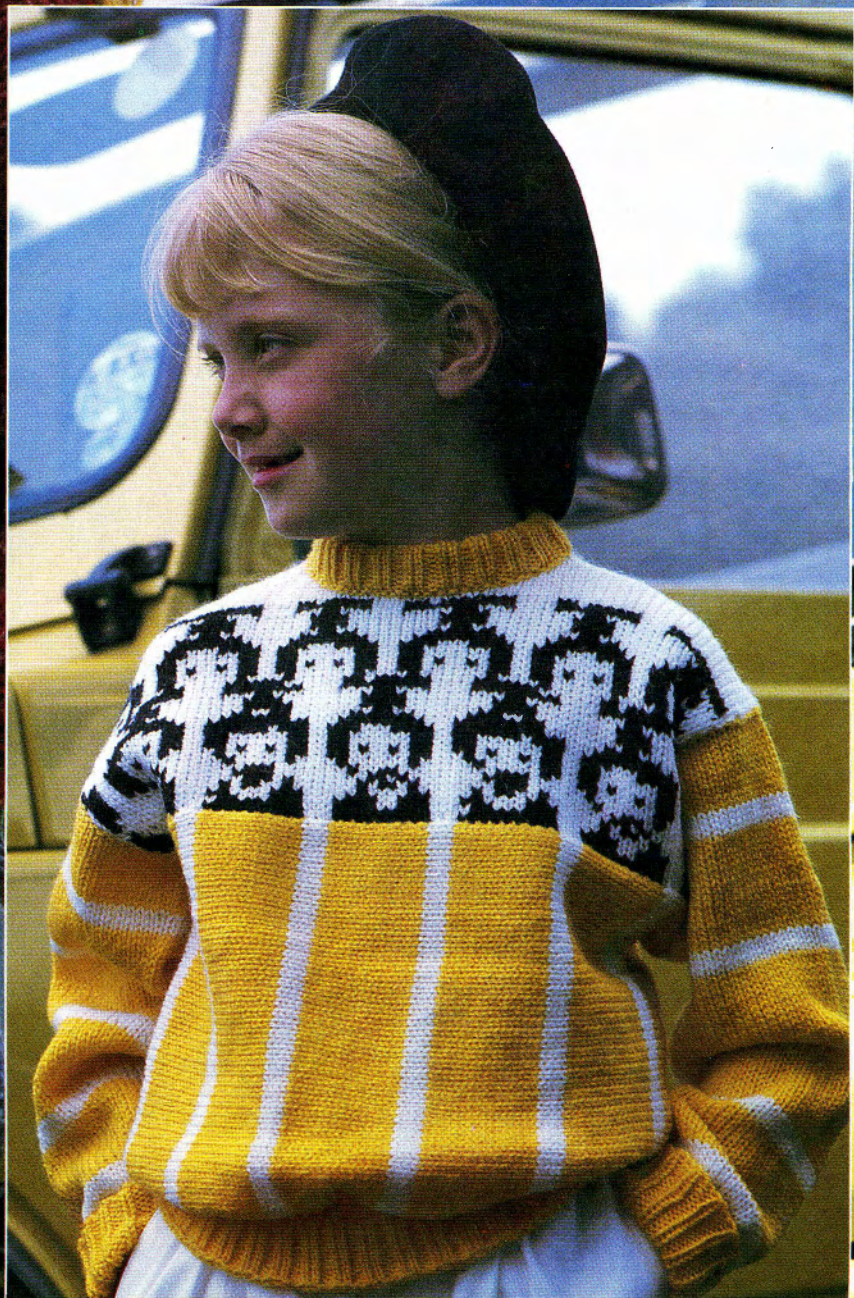
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
