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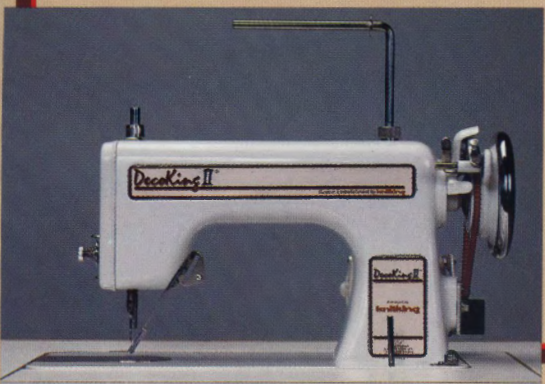

The DecoKing II allows the fabric to be moved by hand in any direction. A lock stitch prevents the yarn or trim from coming off the fabric, giving you 100% coverage on top. This differs from other embroidery machines which puncture yarn through to the back of the fabric.

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# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

## THE SAMPLE SWATCH

It is imperative that you knit a sample swatch for every garment. Although you may be using the identical yarn and machine model as the pattern suggests, many variables such as dye lot difference, speed of knitting and just machine to machine differences can all cause a variance in the gauge achieved. Knit Magazine publishes the tension and gauge for each garment shown. We strongly urge you to knit a swatch representing three tensions - the recommended tension, and .1 or .2 higher and lower. These different tensions can be knitted in one piece with waste yarn separating the sections. This will eliminate unnecessary rethreading while allowing you to obtain the gauge published in the magazine.

To make a sample swatch on standard gauge machines cast on 60 stitches with waste yarn. Knit approximately 6 rows. \*Mark the tension number for your swatch by making holes. For example 4 eyelet holes for Tension 4, 6 eyelet holes for Tension 6. Knit 6 more rows.

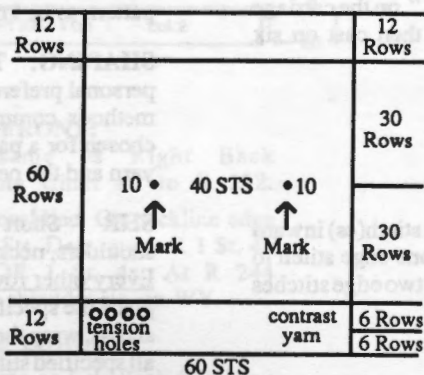
Change to garment yarn and reset row counter to 0. Knit 30 rows (in Pattern stitch). With contrast yarn, mark the 10th stitch FROM EACH SIDE by hand. Knit 30 Rows. Change to waste yarn and knit 6 rows. Change tension up or down for second section and repeat from \*. Make third section with another tension. Remove on 12 Rows of waste yarn. Remove the sts. from the machine

by pushing the Carriage across without yarn.

Pull and stretch the swatch both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner. Gently block the swatch. Treat the swatch as you would the finished garment before measuring the gauge. For example, if you plan to wash this garment and dry it in the dryer, you should do so, measuring before and after to see the difference.

Measure between the stitches marked and the beginning and ending rows for the inches/cms. knitted. Divide the total number of stitches/rows by the inches measured to calculate sts. and rows per inch.

For Bulky knitters, make swatch with 30 Sts. and 30 Rows. If so desired, or for large pattern repeats, we suggest a wider and longer swatch to provide more accurate gauges.



## BUTTONHOLES

The following methods of buttonholes are the general manner in which small and large buttonholes are created.

**Small Buttonholes in Ribbing**  
Make small eyelet style buttonholes by following chart below.



**Large Buttonholes in FNR**  
Vertical buttonholes are made by knitting each side separately (partial or short-row knitting). Knit the right side first, end with yarn on left. Without breaking yarn, knit left side. The strand of yarn inside the buttonhole can be picked up every other row when knitting the left side, but this is not necessary for a small buttonhole.

## SHORT ROWS

### Method One

With carriage on opposite side start placing appropriate number of ndls in HP. Knit across and wrap the inside needle. Again, place appropriate number of ndls in HP on opposite side from carriage, knit across and repeat wrapping. The wrapping will eliminate any holes in the knitting.

### Method Two - Automatic Wrap

Example follows for shoulder short rows. This method can be used for other Short Rowing as well. For example if pattern says to Short Row at shoulder every other row 7 sts, 1 x and 6 sts. 1 x . . . With carriage on opposite side put 6 sts in HP, knit 1 row across and put one additional needle in HP. Opposite carriage place 6 ndls in HP. Knit 1 row across and bring one extra needle to HP. Repeat until shortrowing is completed.

## HEMS

Two methods of knitting hems are described below. Variations on these instructions will allow you to knit plain hems, picot edge hems and more.

### Method One

With waste yarn cast on the required number of stitches and knit about 10-12 rows ending with the carriage on the left. Knit 1 Row to the right with Ravel Cord. Change to garment yarn and knit 1 Row to the left at garment body tension. (i.e. Skirt at Tension 4, 1st row at T 4). Turn tension down approximately 2 full tension numbers lower (tighter) and knit to mid point. (i.e. Row 14 of a 28-row hem). Change tension to 1 full point lower than garment body and knit remainder of hem rows. Pick up the stitches from the first row of garment yarn - shown between the stitches of Ravel Cord. Hem is now completed. Proceed with pattern as per chart and instruc-

tions. Remove waste yarn and Ravel Cord when you have completed section.

### Method Two

Bring required number of needles to "B" (working) position. Attach cast-on comb. Beginning with the 2nd needle on the LEFT, bring every other needle to "D" or "E" position. Push in both Part buttons. Knit 1 Row to the left. Release the part buttons and drop the cast-on comb. (DO NOT REMOVE cast on comb from work). Knit required number of rows for hem. Attach weights to the back of work close to the cast-on comb (about 1/4" above the comb). Beginning with the 1st needle on the LEFT, bring every other needle to "D" position. Carefully LIFT the cast-on comb and hang loops onto the needles in "D" position. Turn the comb back away from you and make sure the needles are through the loops. Pull the needles out to "E" position and remove the cast-on comb.

**AT THE SAME TIME** - Two functions are to be performed at the same time, such as shaping the neck and shoulder. Be sure to read both instructions before proceeding.

**BO - Bind Off.** To take off more than 1 St. at a time. When two or more stitches are to be bound off (or cast on) the carriage and yarn must be on the same side as the bind off. If the instruction is, "At R 100 BO 6 Sts on each side.", on the carriage side BO six stitches, knit one row and then bind off six stitches on the other side. See DECR and FF DECR.

**BOLT - Slip Stitch Bind Off with a Latch Tool.** Knit one row to the left at a tension at least five numbers higher (looser) than the garment tension. Bring all needles to holding position ("E") and then, pick up the first stitch on a latch tool allowing it to slip behind the latch, then pick up the next stitch and pull it through the stitch already on the latch hook, thus creating a slip stitch. If you cannot set the tension at least five full tension numbers higher, knit a row loosely manually.

**CO - Cast on stitches for knitting. (CHECK INSTRUCTION MANUALS TO MAKE SURE DIFFERENT METHODS ARE SHOWN)** In our instructions, CO is used either for a finished edge at the beginning of the garment, or to add edge stitch(es). If two or more stitches are to be cast on the carriage and yarn must be on the same side as the cast on. If the instruction is, "At R 100 CO 6 Sts on each side.", on the carriage side cast on six stitches, knit one row and then cast on six stitches on the other side.

**COR - Carriage on Right**

**COL - Carriage on Left**

**DECN - Use the transfer tool to move the edge stitch(es) inward to the next needle.** Usually used to transfer one edge stitch to the next needle, but may be used to transfer the two edge stitches to the next two needles.

**EON - Every other needle**

**EOR - Every other row**

**EOS - Every other stitch**

**FF DECR - Used to make an even edge for seaming and decorative seams for raglans.** If one stitch is to be decreased, use a two-prong transfer tool to move the two edge stitches inward one needle. If two stitches are to be decreased, use a three-prong transfer tool to move the three edge stitches in two needles. If three stitches are to be decreased, use two two-prong transfer tools and move the edge stitches in four needles. See DECR, BO and SHAPING.

**FF INCR - To increase one stitch move the two edge stitches outward one needle, then fill the empty needle by picking up a bar from the row below and hanging it on the empty needle.**

**FNR - Full Needle Rib**

**G.C. - Garter Carriage**

**HP - Holding position or "E" position.**

**INCR - Increase.** Usually used for "full-fashion" shaping, see FF Incr., or in conjunction with short row shaping. A simple incr can be made by pulling additional needle on side of carriage out to "E" position and knit across.

**MB - Main Bed**

**MC - Main Color**

**Ndls - Needles**

**NWP - Non-working position or position "A"**

**R(s) - Row(s)**

**RB - Ribber Bed**

**RC - Row Counter.**

**RC 0 - Set RC to zero.**

**SET PATTERN - Follow the step-by-step instructions in your manual for setting the pattern and carriage controls for the pattern to be knit, e.g., Fairisle, tuck, single motif, etc.**

**SHAPING:** The method used for shaping is a matter of personal preference. In our definitions we have described the methods commonly in use at Knitking. Which method is chosen for a particular pattern depends upon the garment, the yarn and the personal preference of the designer.

**SHR - Short Row or Partial Knitting.** Used for shaping shoulders, necklines, darts, gores, etc. Set carriage on H(old). **Every other row SHRs:** On the opposite side of the carriage, place the specified number of stitches in holding position, knit across, wrap the inner needle or use an "automatic wrap". After all specified stitches have been placed in HP change the carriage setting to N (knit) to return the needles to WP. **Every row SHRs:** On the side being shaped, place one stitch in HP every row. It is recommended you refer to your manual or an instruction book for detailed instructions about how to short row.

**St(s) - Stitch(es)**

**St. St. - Stockinette stitch.**

**T - Tension.**

**WP - Working Position or "B" position.**

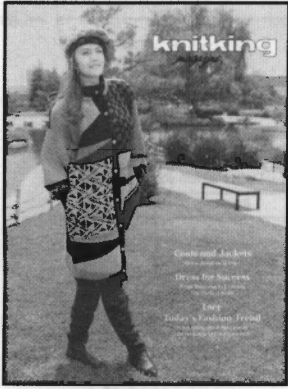
**WY - Waste yarn.**

**YM - Yarn marker.** To place a yarn marker, use a short piece of contrasting yarn and loop it over the needle specified or the end needle of the row specified.

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## SEAMING GARMENTS

Any number of popular methods are suggested. We encourage you to experiment with any and all. If a garment in Knitking Magazine requires special seaming information it will be provided in the individual pattern instruction. Otherwise, methods include: linking on the knitting machine, Knitking's Lectrolink, the electric linker, crochet slip stitch, tapestry needles with back stitch sewing by hand. Bar to bar weaving for seamless appearance and seaming on a sewing machine.

With WY CO 50 Sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the right. RC 0. T 3. Col. 3.

Chart #1. Knit to R 80 and place a YM on left side for pocket. At R 134 place a YM on left side for pocket. At R 162 place a YM on left side for armhole. At R 244 mark 18 Sts. from right with YM for neckline. Remove sts. on WY.

**CENTER BACK:**

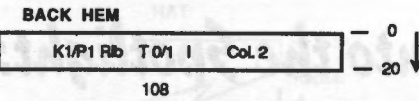
With WY CO 14 Sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the left. T 5. Col. 5. Tuck #2. Knit 1 R to set pattern. RC 0. Knit in tuck stitch to R 280 and remove sts. on WY.

**RIGHT BACK:**

Knit same as Left Back following Chart #2 and reversing YM's.

**BACK HEM:**

With purl side facing, rehang lower edge of Left/Center/Right Back on 108 ndls. decr. evenly across. Col. 2. Knit 1 R at T 3 and transfer EOS to RB. RC 0. T 0/1 I. Knit 20 Rs., knitting last R at T 10/8. Transfer RB Sts. to MB and BOLT.

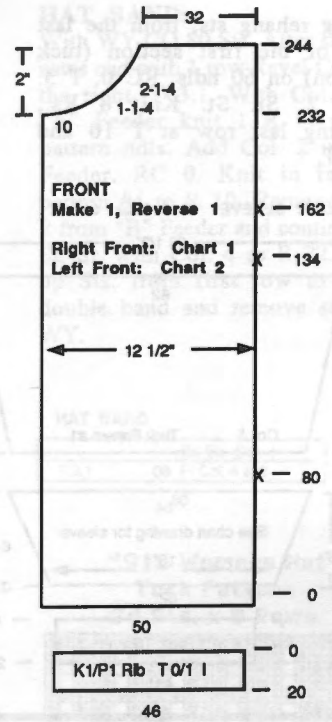


**LEFT FRONT:**

Knit same as Right Back following Chart #2 to R 232. Shape neckline. On neckline edge BO 10 Sts. Decr. every R 1 St. 4x and EOR 1 St. 4x. At R 244 remove shoulder sts. on WY.

**RIGHT FRONT:**

Knit same as Left Back following Chart #1 and reversing shapings.

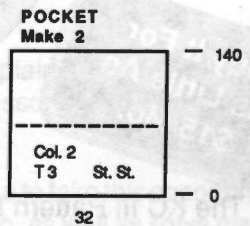


**FRONT HEM:** Make 2.

With purl side facing, rehang lower edge of Left/Right Front on 46 ndls. decr. evenly across. Col. 2. Knit 1 R at T 3 and transfer EOS to RB. RC 0. T 0/1 I. Knit 20 Rs., knitting last R at T 10/8. Transfer RB Sts. to MB and BOLT.

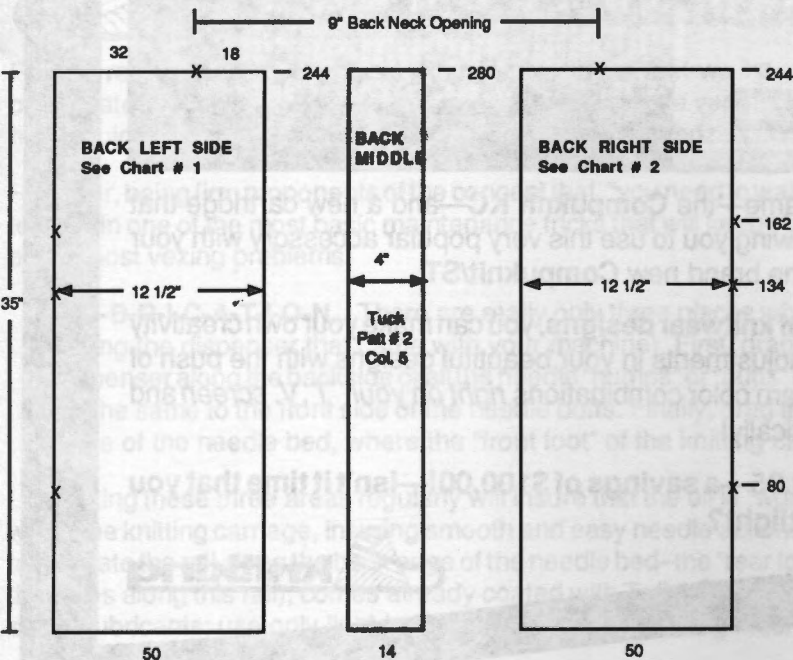
**POCKET:** Make 2

With purl side facing, rehang front between pocket markers on 32 ndls. RC 0. T 3. Col. 2. St. St. Knit 140 Rs. With knit side facing rehang back between pocket markers on these ndls. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

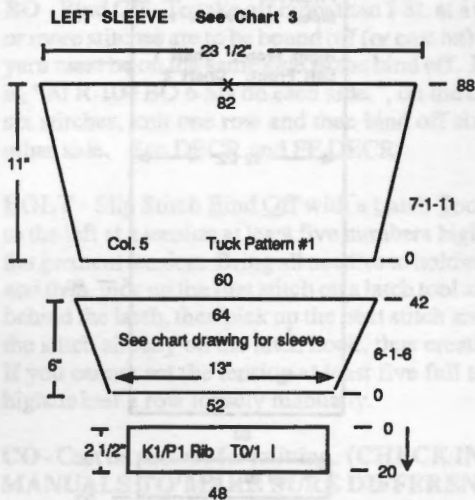


**LEFT SLEEVE:**

With WY CO 52 Sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the right. RC 0. T 3. Col. 4. Chart #3. Shape sides by incr. on each side every 6 Rs. 1 St. 6x. At R 42 remove sts. on WY. With knit side facing, rehang upper edge of sleeve on 60 ndls. decr. evenly across. RC 0. T 5. Col. 5. Tuck Pattern #1. Knit in tuck pattern while incr. on each side every 7 Rs. 1 St. 11x. At R 88 BO very loosely. With knit side

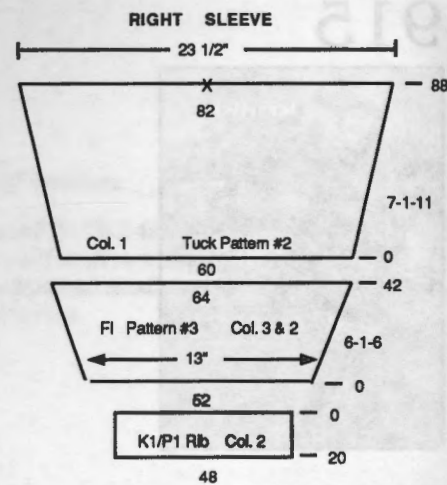


facing rehang sts. from the last row of the first section (tuck section) on 60 ndls. RC 0. T 3. Col. 2. St. St. Knit 8 Rs., knitting last row at T 10 and BOLT.



**RIGHT SLEEVE:**

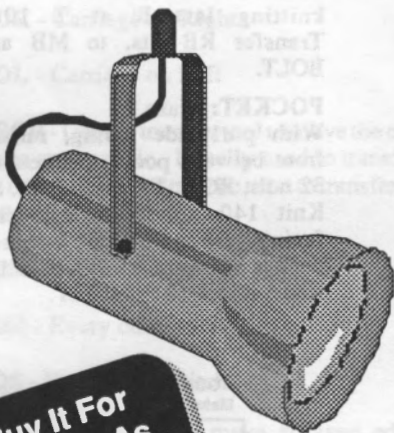
With WY CO 52 Sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the right. RC 0. T 3. Col. 3 in "A" Feeder and Col. 2 in "B" Feeder. Fairisle Pattern #3. Knit in fairisle while shaping sides by incr. on each side every 6 Rs. 1 St. 6x. At R 42 remove sts. on WY. With knit side facing, rehang upper edge of sleeve on 60 ndls. decr. evenly across. RC 0. T 5. Col. 1. Tuck Pattern #2. Knit in tuck pattern while incr. on each side every 7 Rs. 1 St. 11x. At R 88 BO very loosely. With knit side facing rehang sts. from the last row of the first section on 60 ndls. RC 0. T 3. Col. 4. St. St. Knit 8 Rs., knitting last row at T 10 and BOLT.



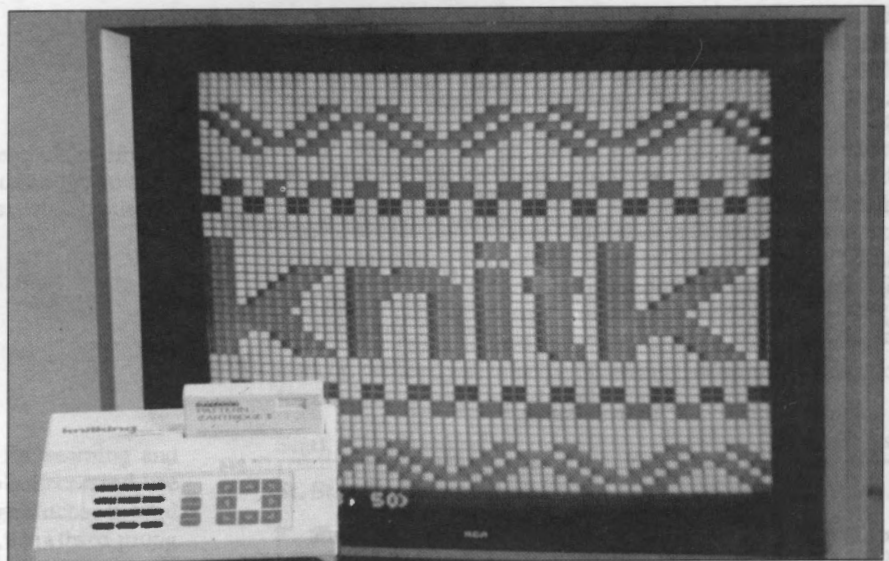
**FRONT BAND:** Make 1 with buttonholes, 1 without. With Col. 2 CO 14 Sts. for K1/P1 Rib. After selvedge, T 0/1 I. RC

0. Knit to R 16 and make buttonhole by marking 3 Sts. with WY. Continue to R 242 following chart for buttonhole placement, knitting last row at T 10 and BOLT.

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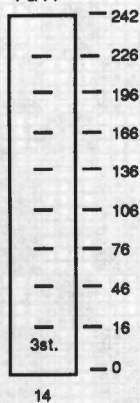

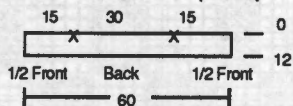

**NECKBAND ROLL (Col. 3)**

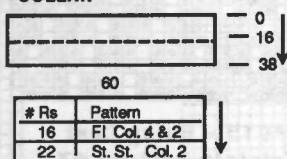


**COLLAR:**

With purl side facing, rehang the neckline Sts. again to make collar. T 3. RC 0. Fairisle Pattern #4. With Col. 4 in "A" Feeder, knit 1 row to select ndls. Add Col. 2 in "B" Feeder and knit to R 16. Change to Col. 2. St. St.

Knit to R 38 and pick up sts. from first row to form hem. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

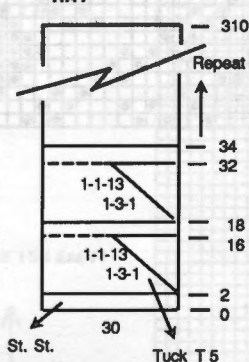
**COLLAR**



**HAT:**

Worn on the purl side. With WY.CO 30 Sts. After several rows end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the left. Change to Col. 3. RC 0. T 5.0. Knit 1 R to the right to select ndls. for Tuck Pattern. Depress tuck buttons and knit 1 R to the left. \*Start SHR, using automatic wrap (See General Instructions) every R 3 Sts. 1x and 1 St. 13x. Then reverse SHR every R 1 St. 13x and 3 Sts. 1x. Knit 2 Rs. in tuck pattern and repeat from \* to R 310. Pick up sts. from first row for seam. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

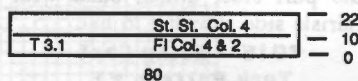

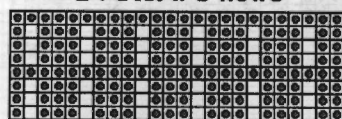
**HAT BAND:**

With WY CO 80 Sts. After several rows end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the right. T 3.1. With Col. 4 in "A" Feeder knit 1 R to select pattern ndls. Add Col. 2 in "B" Feeder. RC 0. Knit in fairisle pattern #4 to R 10. Remove Col. 2 from "B" Feeder and continue in St. St. with Col. 4 to R 22. Pick up Sts. from first row to form double band and remove sts. on WY.

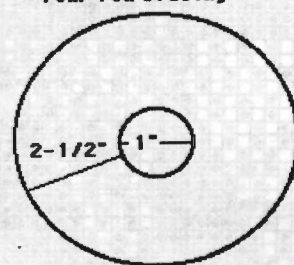

**knit** technical tips

Faithful readers of our Technical Tips column know that we have always used this column to explain some of the more complicated issues that have come up with regards to the various knitting machines and major accessories. This, generally, has required us to concentrate on the electronic/computerized accessories as topics of discussion.

However, being firm proponents of the concept that, "you need to walk before you can run," we would like to take this opportunity to explain one of the most basic maintenance tricks that will keep your knitting machines purring along, as well as solve many of the most vexing problems:

**L-U-B-R-I-C-A-T-I-O-N.** There are really only three places where you need to *lightly* add oil (using the dispenser that came with your machine). First, drag the applicator tip of the oil dispenser along the backside of all the needle "humps" or "butts" from one end to the other. Next, do the same to the front side of the needle butts. Finally, drag the applicator tip along the front edge of the needle bed, where the "front foot" of the knitting carriage travels (see Figure 1).

Lubricating these three areas regularly will insure that the oil is "worked into" the needle pathways within the knitting carriage, insuring smooth and easy needle action. Furthermore, there is no need to lubricate the rail along the back edge of the needle bed—the "rear foot" of the carriage (the channel that rides along this rail), comes already coated with Teflon®, providing permanent lubrication. Finally, do not use any type of silicon lubricants; use only light industrial oil, such as knitting machine oil (available from Knitking) or sewing machine oil.

*Drag the oil dispenser applicator along this edge from one end to the other.*

# knitking news

## KNITTING LOVELY LACE

One of the most fashionable looks this season is lace. It's everywhere in the design world—sweaters, edgings on leggings, hanging out below sheer skirts—you can't escape! Time to get the lace carriage out of the top of your machine lid and join the hottest fashion scene this year!

We've used knitted lace in several very different and versatile ways in Patterns 919, 922 and 926. Sleeves only, in the body to make way for ribbon accents, and in an all-over lace pullover perfect for the warm weather. If you follow these few helpful hints and reminders, lace is not difficult to knit.

First, remember to weight your fabric carefully and place your weights evenly. As in all knitting, too much weight can be just as much trouble as too little. If you drop stitches, you should not necessarily add weight, as this may make the dropped stitch situation even worse. Experiment with the proper amount of weights and also the tension when practicing with each yarn. Lace is usually knitted at a slightly different tension than the same yarn in the stockinette style. This minor adjustment either up or down, just one dot, can rectify the problem of dropped stitches in lace.

Second, to create lace remember that the lace carriage transfers the stitch from one needle to the next. This is accomplished when you move in one direction—you cannot transfer over 2 stitches together at one time. This is added work for your machine, beyond normal stockinette knitting. In order to assist the yarn and machine it is usually a good idea to use yarn spray wax on your cone before knitting as this will make the yarn flow more easily through the machine and carriages.

Third, experiment with different yarns and techniques. When first knitting lace, try smooth yarns for beginning projects, and then move on to more textured or shiny yarns as you become more comfortable with lace knitting.

When knitting in a lace pattern, whether on a punchcard or electronic machine, remember that the K-Carriage is set to N (or NL) and only the Lace Carriage advances the pattern rows on the punch card. The K-Carriage does not advance the pattern, but does advance the Row Counter. Usually two rows are knitted with the K-Carriage between lace carriage movement, but it is possible to knit any number of even rows between the lace transfers. This can produce quite a different look with the same card. Remember our third hint—experiment—and have fun.

And remember those extension rails . . . you don't want to end up with one of your carriages on the floor!

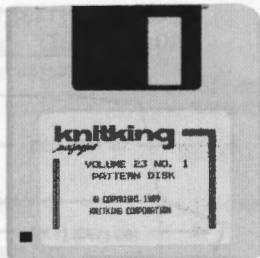
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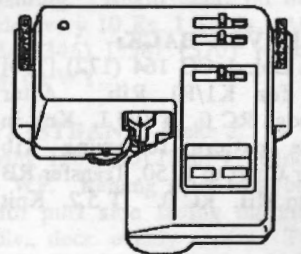

**GIRLS BRAID:**

Make 3 Strips, 1 ea. in Col. 1, Col. 3 and Col. 2. 'e' wrap CO 8 Sts. RC 0. T 3.1. Knit 100 Rs. and BO. Braid the 3 strips together. Attach Pom Pom to the braid. Use pom-pom maker or wrap yarn (Col. 1) around a 2" piece of cardboard until desired fullness. Tie in center and cut one end.

**FINISHING:**

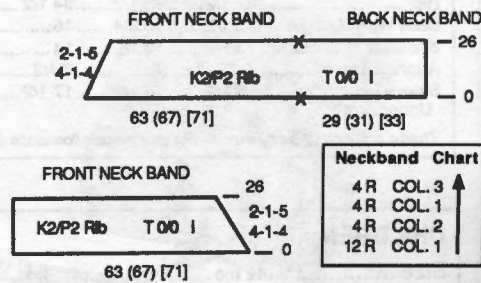
Attach Band to circle decr. evenly on each triangle. Sew open seam. Attach Brim to Boys hat and Braid to Girls hat.



## #934 - Mens Bulky V-Neck Needle Arrangement



All MB ndls. must be in WP. (Take bar from RB to make new st. on MB and take bar from MB to make new st. on RB). Reset RC to 0. T 4/3 I. Col. 1. Knit 1 R to the right. Set carriage at KC. T 3.2/3 I and knit 1 R to the left to select ndls. Depress both tuck buttons. Knit in pattern to R 94 (98) [102] and mark each side with a YM for armhole. Continue in pattern to R 176 (184) [192]. Transfer RB Sts. to MB. Knit 1 R at T 10. Mark center 26 (28) [30] Sts. with a YM for neckline opening and BOLT.



10x [(every 8 Rs. 1 St. 14x)]. At R 110 (114) [118] transfer RB Sts. to MB. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

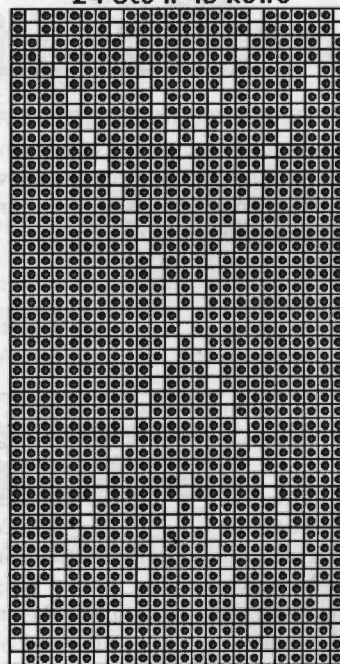
**NECKBAND:** Make in 2 pieces. **Back/Front:** Close one shoulder. With knit side facing rehang back/front on 92 (98) [104] ndls. as shown on chart. With Col. 1 knit 1 R st. st. at T 3.2. Transfer sts. from MB to RB for K2/P2 Rib. RC 0. T 0/0 I. Follow color chart and shape center of 'V' by decr. every 4 Rs. 1 St. 4x and EOR 1 St. 5x. At R 26 transfer RB Sts. to MB. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

**Front:** With knit side facing rehang front on 63 (67) [71] ndls. and complete same as Back/Front reversing shaping.

**FRONT:** Knit same as back to R 50 (54) [58]. Shape neckline. Note pattern row. Place all Sts. to the left of -0- in HP. \*On neckline edge decr. every 9 Rs. 1 St. 13x (every 8 Rs. 1 St. 14x) [every 8 Rs. 1 St. 15x]. At R 94 (98) [102] mark edge with a YM for armhole. Continue to R 176 (184) [192]. Transfer RB Sts. to MB. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT. Put left side Sts. into WP. Reset RC to R 50 (54) [58]. Reset to proper pattern row and shape neckline from \* reversing shapings.

**SLEEVE:** Make 2 the same. With Col. 3 CO 46 (46) [50] Sts. for K2/P2 Rib. After selvedge RC 0. T 0/0 I. Knit 29 rows following color chart ending with carriage on left. Incr. 2 Sts. on each side for Size (10/12) and [14]. Arrange ndls. same as back. Reset RC to 0. T 4/3.1 I. Col. 1. Knit 1 R to the right. Set carriage at KC. T 3.2/3 I and knit 1 R to the left to select ndls. Depress both tuck buttons. Knit in pattern incr. on each side every 7 Rs. 1 St. 4x and every 8 Rs. 1 St.
