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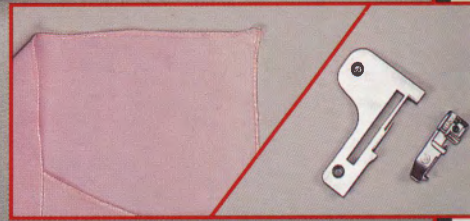

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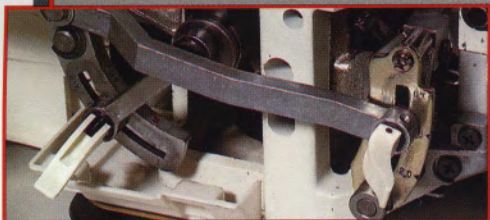

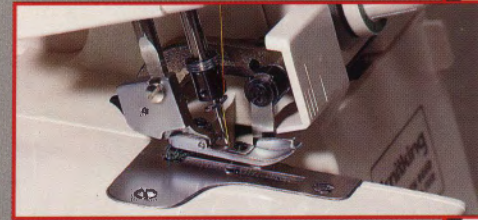

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# GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

## THE SAMPLE SWATCH

It is imperative that you knit a sample swatch for every garment. Although you may be using the identical yarn and machine model as the pattern suggests, many variables such as dye lot difference, speed of knitting and just machine to machine differences can all cause a variance in the gauge achieved. Knit Magazine publishes the tension and gauge for each garment shown. We strongly urge you to knit a swatch representing three tensions - the recommended tension, and .1 or .2 higher and lower. These different tensions can be knitted in one piece with waste yarn separating the sections. This will eliminate unnecessary rethreading while allowing you to obtain the gauge published in the magazine.

To make a sample swatch on standard gauge machines cast on 60 stitches with waste yarn. Knit approximately 6 rows. \*Mark the tension number for your swatch by making holes. For example 4 eyelet holes for Tension 4, 6 eyelet holes for Tension 6. Knit 6 more rows.

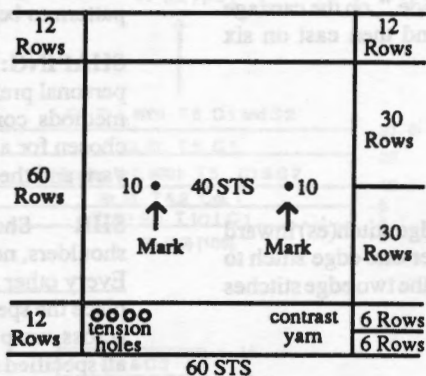
Change to garment yarn and reset row counter to 0. Knit 30 rows (in Pattern stitch). With contrast yarn, mark the 10th stitch FROM EACH SIDE by hand. Knit 30 Rows. Change to waste yarn and knit 6 rows. Change tension up or down for second section and repeat from \*. Make third section with another tension. Remove on 12 Rows of waste yarn. Remove the sts. from the machine

by pushing the Carriage across without yarn.

Pull and stretch the swatch both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner. Gently block the swatch. Treat the swatch as you would the finished garment before measuring the gauge. For example, if you plan to wash this garment and dry it in the dryer, you should do so, measuring before and after to see the difference.

Measure between the stitches marked and the beginning and ending rows for the inches/cms. knitted. Divide the total number of stitches/rows by the inches measured to calculate sts. and rows per inch.

For Bulky knitters, make swatch with 30 Sts. and 30 Rows. If so desired, or for large pattern repeats, we suggest a wider and longer swatch to provide more accurate gauges.



## BUTTONHOLES

The following methods of buttonholes are the general manner in which small and large buttonholes are created.

**Small Buttonholes in Ribbing**  
Make small eyelet style buttonholes by following chart below.

**Buttonhole Transfer**  
Center St. of Each Bed to Next St. of Other Bed



**Large Buttonholes in FNR**  
Vertical buttonholes are made by knitting each side separately (partial or short-row knitting). Knit the right side first, end with yarn on left. Without breaking yarn, knit left side. The strand of yarn inside the buttonhole can be picked up every other row when knitting the left side, but this is not necessary for a small buttonhole.

## SHORT ROWS

### Method One

With carriage on opposite side start placing appropriate number of ndls in HP. Knit across and wrap the inside needle. Again, place appropriate number of ndls in HP on opposite side from carriage, knit across and repeat wrapping. The wrapping will eliminate any holes in the knitting.

### Method Two - Automatic Wrap

Example follows for shoulder short rows. This method can be used for other Short Rowing as well. For example if pattern says to Short Row at shoulder every other row 7 sts, 1 x and 6 sts. 1 x . . . With carriage on opposite side put 6 sts in HP, knit 1 row across and put one additional needle in HP. Opposite carriage place 6 ndls in HP. Knit 1 row across and bring one extra needle to HP. Repeat until shortrowing is completed.

## HEMS

Two methods of knitting hems are described below. Variations on these instructions will allow you to knit plain hems, picot edge hems and more.

### Method One

With waste yarn cast on the required number of stitches and knit about 10-12 rows ending with the carriage on the left. Knit 1 Row to the right with Ravel Cord. Change to garment yarn and knit 1 Row to the left at garment body tension. (i.e. Skirt at Tension 4, 1st row at T 4). Turn tension down approximately 2 full tension numbers lower (tighter) and knit to mid point. (i.e. Row 14 of a 28-row hem). Change tension to 1 full point lower than garment body and knit remainder of hem rows. Pick up the stitches from the first row of garment yarn - shown between the stitches of Ravel Cord. Hem is now completed. Proceed with pattern as per chart and instruc-

tions. Remove waste yarn and Ravel Cord when you have completed section.

### Method Two

Bring required number of needles to "B" (working) position. Attach cast-on comb. Beginning with the 2nd needle on the LEFT, bring every other needle to "D" or "E" position. Push in both Part buttons. Knit 1 Row to the left. Release the part buttons and drop the cast-on comb. (DO NOT REMOVE cast on comb from work). Knit required number of rows for hem. Attach weights to the back of work close to the cast-on comb (about 1/4" above the comb). Beginning with the 1st needle on the LEFT, bring every other needle to "D" position. Carefully LIFT the cast-on comb and hang loops onto the needles in "D" position. Turn the comb back away from you and make sure the needles are through the loops. Pull the needles out to "E" position and remove the cast-on comb.

**AT THE SAME TIME** - Two functions are to be performed at the same time, such as shaping the neck and shoulder. Be sure to read both instructions before proceeding.

**BO** - Bind Off. To take off more than 1 St. at a time. When two or more stitches are to be bound off (or cast on) the carriage and yarn must be on the same side as the bind off. If the instruction is, "At R 100 BO 6 Sts on each side.", on the carriage side BO six stitches, knit one row and then bind off six stitches on the other side. See DECR and FF DECR.

**BOLT** - Slip Stitch Bind Off with a Latch Tool. Knit one row to the left at a tension at least five numbers higher (looser) than the garment tension. Bring all needles to holding position ("E") and then, pick up the first stitch on a latch tool allowing it to slip behind the latch, then pick up the next stitch and pull it through the stitch already on the latch hook, thus creating a slip stitch. If you cannot set the tension at least five full tension numbers higher, knit a row loosely manually.

**CO** - Cast on stitches for knitting. (CHECK INSTRUCTION MANUALS TO MAKE SURE DIFFERENT METHODS ARE SHOWN) In our instructions, CO is used either for a finished edge at the beginning of the garment, or to add edge stitch(es). If two or more stitches are to be cast on the carriage and yarn must be on the same side as the cast on. If the instruction is, "At R 100 CO 6 Sts on each side.", on the carriage side cast on six stitches, knit one row and then cast on six stitches on the other side.

**COR** - Carriage on Right

**COL** - Carriage on Left

**DEC**R - Use the transfer tool to move the edge stitch(es) inward to the next needle. Usually used to transfer one edge stitch to the next needle, but may be used to transfer the two edge stitches to the next two needles.

**EON** - Every other needle

**EOR** - Every other row

**EOS** - Every other stitch

**FF DE**CR - Used to make an even edge for seaming and decorative seams for raglans. If one stitch is to be decreased, use a two-prong transfer tool to move the two edge stitches inward one needle. If two stitches are to be decreased, use a three-prong transfer tool to move the three edge stitches in two needles. If three stitches are to be decreased, use two two-prong transfer tools and move the edge stitches in four needles. See DECR, BO and SHAPING.

**FF IN**CR - To increase one stitch move the two edge stitches outward one needle, then fill the empty needle by picking up a bar from the row below and hanging it on the empty needle.

**FNR** - Full Needle Rib

**G.C.** - Garter Carriage

**HP** - Holding position or "E" position.

**IN**CR - Increase. Usually used for "full-fashion" shaping, see FF Incr., or in conjunction with short row shaping. A simple incr can be made by pulling additional needle on side of carriage out to "E" position and knit across.

**MB** - Main Bed

**MC** - Main Color

**Ndls** - Needles

**NWP** - Non-working position or position "A"

**R(s)** - Row(s)

**RB** - Ribber Bed

**RC** - Row Counter.

**RC 0** - Set RC to zero.

**SET PATTERN** - Follow the step-by-step instructions in your manual for setting the pattern and carriage controls for the pattern to be knit, e.g., Fairisle, tuck, single motif, etc.

**SHAPING**: The method used for shaping is a matter of personal preference. In our definitions we have described the methods commonly in use at Knitking. Which method is chosen for a particular pattern depends upon the garment, the yarn and the personal preference of the designer.

**SHR** - Short Row or Partial Knitting. Used for shaping shoulders, necklines, darts, gores, etc. Set carriage on H(old). **Every other row SHRs**: On the opposite side of the carriage, place the specified number of stitches in holding position, knit across, wrap the inner needle or use an "automatic wrap". After all specified stitches have been placed in HP change the carriage setting to N (knit) to return the needles to WP. **Every row SHRs**: On the side being shaped, place one stitch in HP every row. It is recommended you refer to your manual or an instruction book for detailed instructions about how to short row.

**St(s)** - Stitch(es)

**St. St.** - Stockinette stitch.

**T** - Tension.

**WP** - Working Position or "B" position.

**WY** - Waste yarn.

**YM** - Yarn marker. To place a yarn marker, use a short piece of contrasting yarn and loop it over the needle specified or the end needle of the row specified.

## SEAMING GARMENTS

Any number of popular methods are suggested. We encourage you to experiment with any and all. If a garment in Knitking Magazine requires special seaming information it will be provided in the individual pattern instruction. Otherwise, methods include: linking on the knitting machine, Knitking's Lectrolink, the electric linker, crochet slip stitch, tapestry needles with back stitch sewing by hand. Bar to bar weaving for seamless appearance and seaming on a sewing machine.

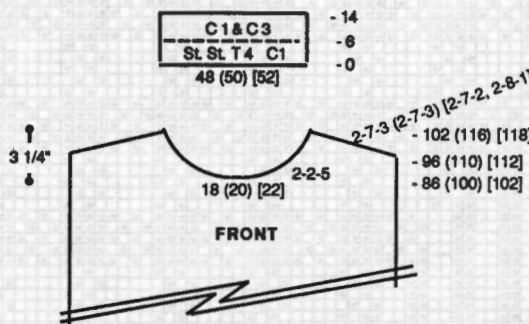
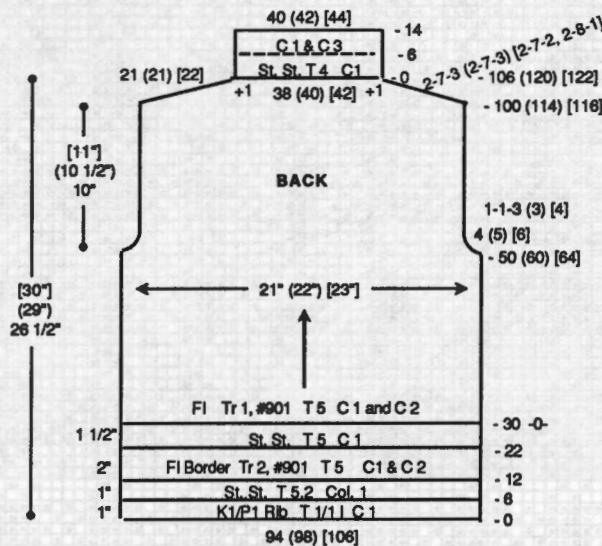
With Col. 1 CO 94 (98) [106] sts. for K1/P1 Rib. After selvedge RC 0. T 1/1 I. Knit to R 6. Transfer RB sts. to MB. T 5.2. St. St. Knit to R 12. Load Track 2, Pattern # 901. Knit 1 row to select ndls. Add Col. 2 in 'B' Feeder. T 5. Knit to R 22. Cut Col. 2. St. St. Knit

to R 30. Load Track 1, Pattern # 901. Knit 1 row to select ndls. Add Col. 2 in 'B' Feeder. Knit to R 50 (60) [64]. Shape armhole. On each side BO 4 (5) [6] sts. then decr. every R 1 St. 3x (every R 1 St. 3x) [every R 1 St. 4x]. At R 100 (114) [116] BO shoulders EOR 7 Sts. 3x (7 Sts. 3x) [7 Sts. 2x and 8 Sts. 1x]. Start back neckband. Incr. 1 st. on each side. RC 0. T 4. St. St. Col. 1. Knit to R 6. Add Col. 3 and knit to R 14. Pick up sts. from first row. Knit 1 row at T 10 and BOLT.

neckline to total 48 (50) [52] sts. for front neckband. RC 0. T 4. St. St. Col. 1. Knit to R 6. Add Col. 3 and knit to R 14. Pick up sts. from first row. Knit 1 row at T 10 and BOLT.

**SLEEVE: Make 2 the same.**

With WY CO 56 (60) [64] sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the left. Load Track 2, Pattern # 901. Col. 1. Knit 1 row to select ndls. Add Col. 2 in 'B' Feeder. T 5. Knit in fairisle. At R 10 inc. 1 st. on each side. Change to Col. 1. St. St. Knit to R 18 and incr. 1 St. on each side. Reset RC to 0. Load Track 2, Pattern # 902. Add Col. 2 in 'B' Feeder and knit in fairisle while incr. on each side every 4 Rs. 1 St. 8x and every 3 Rs. 1 St. 5x (every 4 Rs. 1 St. 13x) [every 5 Rs. 1 St. 10x and every 4 Rs. 1 St. 3x]. At R 50 (60) [66] shape sleeve cap. On each side BO 5 sts., then SHR EOR 4 Sts. 5x. At R 60 (70) [76] knit 1 row over all sts. at T 10 and BOLT.

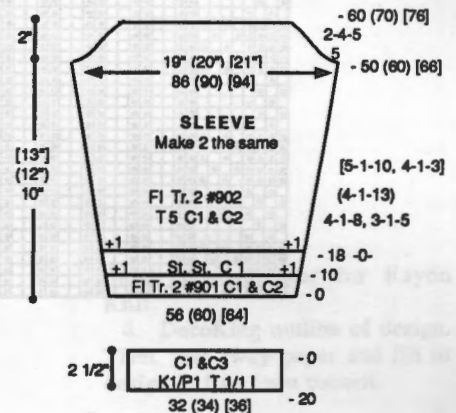


**FRONT:**

Knit front same as back to R 86 (100) [102]. Shape neckline. Place center 18 (20) [22] sts. in HP and all sts. to the left. Note pattern row. \*SHR neckline edge EOR 2 Sts. 5x. At R 96 (110) [112] BO shoulder EOR 7 Sts. 3x (7 Sts. 3x) [7 Sts. 2x and 8 Sts. 1x]. Reset RC to 86 (100) [102]. Reset pattern to correct row and shape left neckline and shoulder from \*, reversing shapings. Pick up extra sts. on each side of

**SLEEVE CUFF: Make 2.**

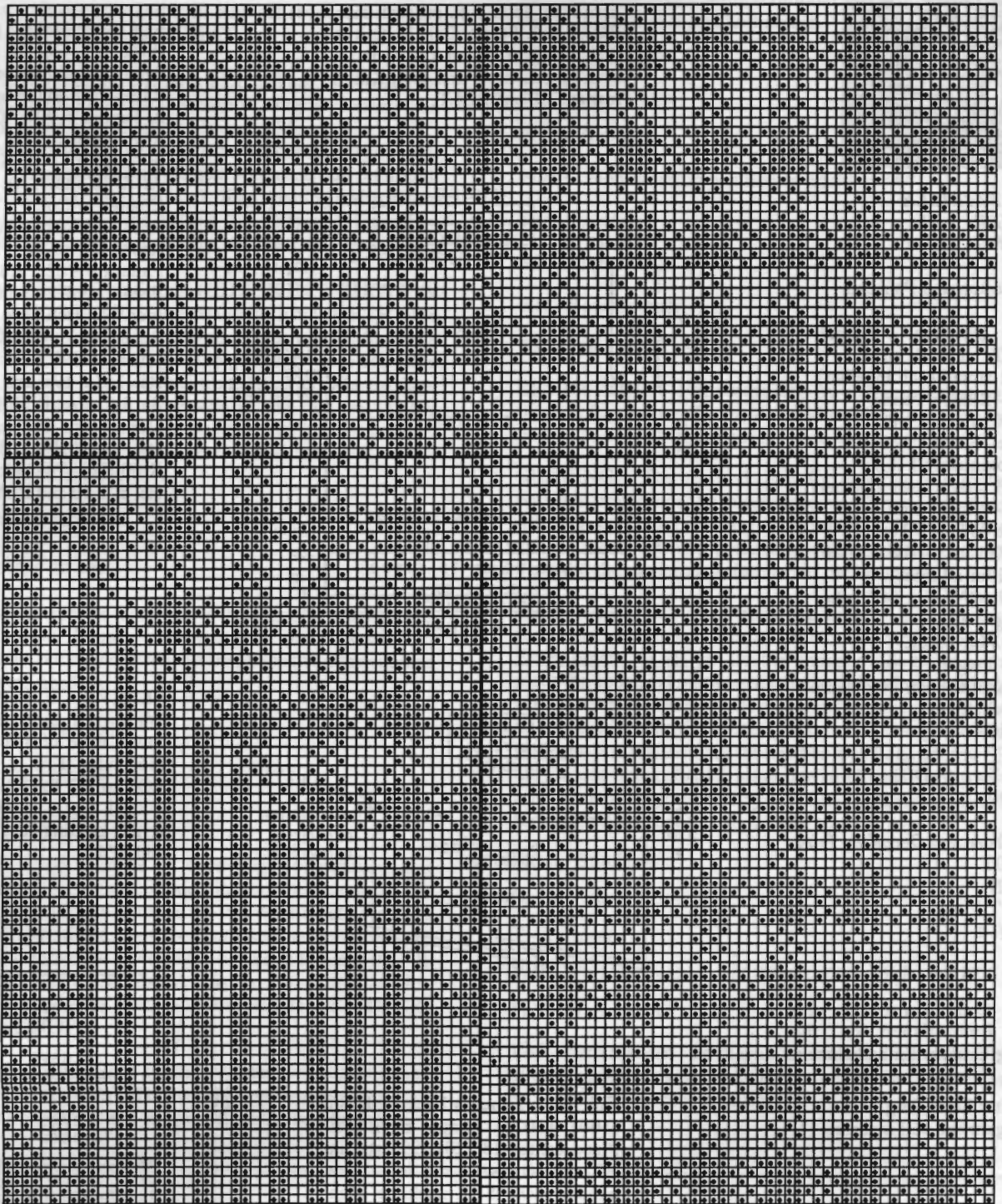
With purl side facing, rehang lower edge of sleeve on 32 (34) [36] ndls. Knit 1 row. Transfer EOS to RB for K1/P1 Rib. RC 0. T 1/1 I. Col. 1 and Col. 3. Knit to R 20, knitting last row at T 10/5 and BOLT.



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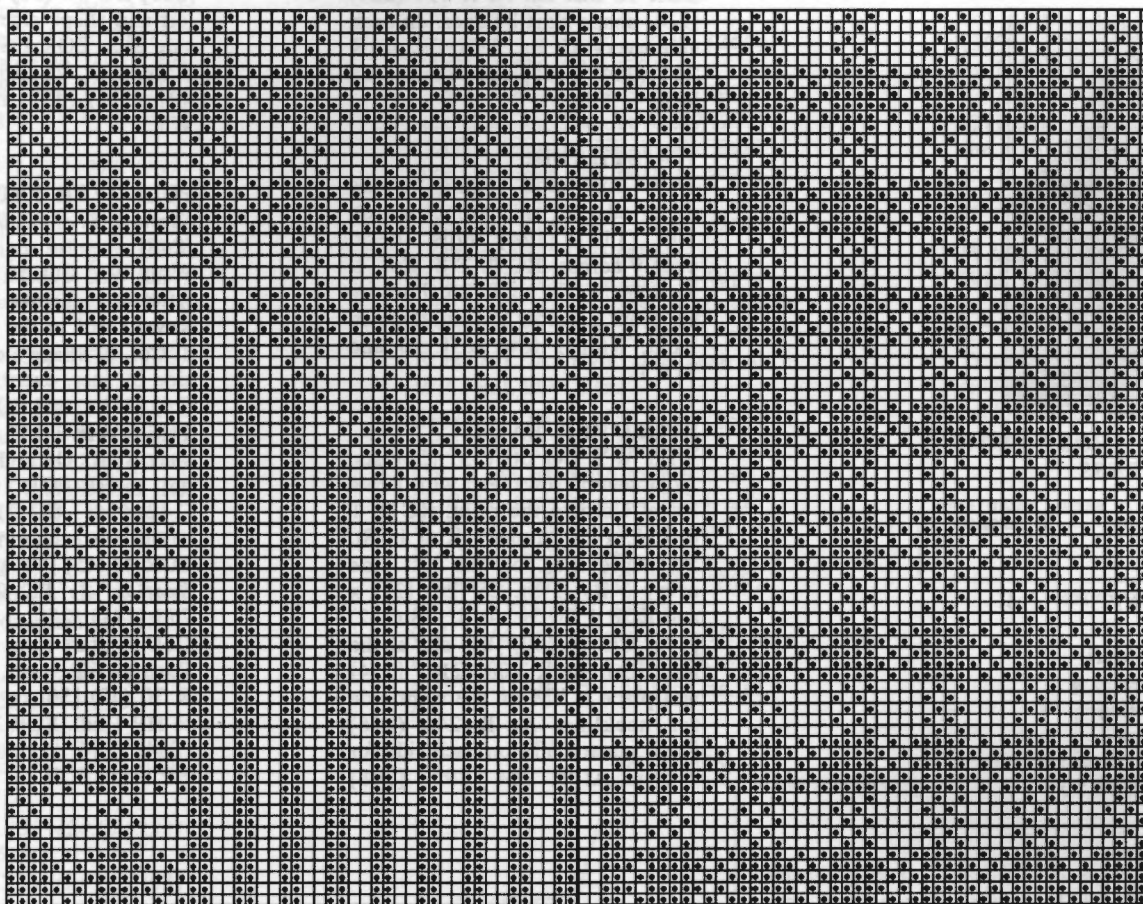

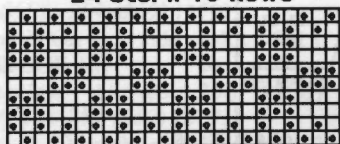

1. Trace desired design (free-form flowers) on tissue paper or tear-away paper.

2. Iron freezer paper on back (purl side) of each garment piece.

3. Use Medium Feed Finger on DecoKing for Alpine yarn and

Small Feed Finger for Rayon Knit.

4. DecoKing outline of design. Then, tear away paper and fill in design in free form pattern.

Close shoulder seams. Slip Stitch sleeves to body. Close all remaining seams.

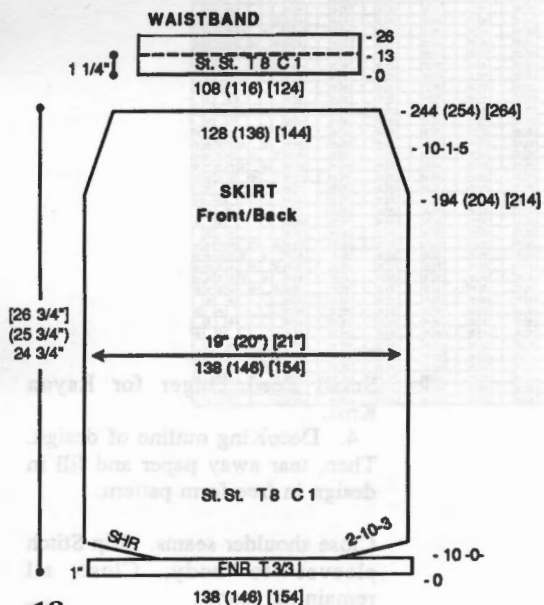

**WAISTBAND:**

With purl side facing rehang upper edge of skirt front/back on 108 (116) [124] ndls. decr. evenly across. RC 0. T 8. Col. 1. Knit in St. St. to R 26. Pick up sts. from first row to form doubled band. Knit 1 row at T 10 and BOLT.

**PULLOVER BACK:**

With WY CO 50 (53) [56] sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the right. RC 0. T 8. Col. 1 (2 strands). Knit in St. St. while incr. on the left side every 5 Rs. 1 St. 25 (26) [27] x and EOR 1 St. 5x. At R 138 (142) [146] CO 76 (80) [84] sts. at the left. Knit to R 208 (216) [224] and place a YM on the right side for neckline. At R 246 (256) [266] place a YM on each side for center. At R 284 (296) [308]

place a YM on the right side for neckline. Knit to R 353 (369) [385] BO 76 (80) [84] sts. at the left and shape sleeve. On the left side decr. EOR 1 St. 5x and every 5 Rs. 1 St. 25 (26) [27] x. At R 492 (512) [532] remove sts. on WY.

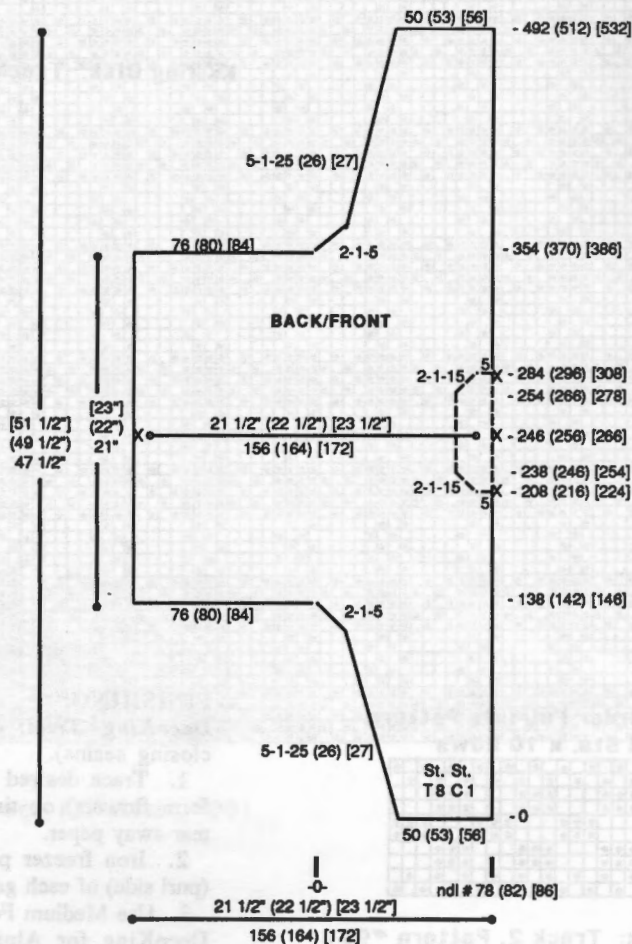
**PULLOVER FRONT:**

**Section 1:** RC 0 to 223 (233) [243].

With WY CO 50 (53) [56] sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the right. RC 0. T 8. Col. 2. Shape sleeve on the left side by incr. every 5 Rs. 1 St. 25 (26) [27] x and EOR 1 St. 5x. AT THE SAME TIME at R 9 (19) [29] start SHR. On right side bring 1 ndl. to HP EOR 107x. At R 138 (142) [146] CO 71 (69) [68] sts. at the left and bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 43 (45) [48] x.

**Section 2:** RC 9 (19) [29] to 233 (243) [253].

Col. 3. Start from left with 2 sts. Push to WP 1 ndl. EOR 107x. At R 30 (40) [50] on the right bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 101x. At R 224 (234) [244] on the left bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 4x.



**Section 3:** RC 30 (40) [50] to 223 (233) [243].

Col. 2. At R 30 (40) [50] start from right. Push to WP 1 ndl. EOR 75x. After R 117 (127) [137] on the right bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 53x. At R 180 (190) [200] on the left bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 21x.

**Section 4:** RC 117 (127) [137] to 233 (243) [253].

Col. 3. At left push to WP 1 ndl. EOR 53x. At right bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 47x. After R 224 (234) [244] on the left bring to HP 1 ndl. EOR 4x.

**Section 5:** RC 138 (148) [158] to 233 (243) [253].

Col. 1. Start from right with 2 ndls. At left push to WP 1 ndl. EOR 47x. At R 208 (216) [224] shape neckline. On right side BO 5 sts., then decr. EOR 1 St. 15x.

## knitking news

### RIBBER TIP FOR THE BULKY

When knitting a garment from the lower edge of ribber straight up into the body of the garment, the bulky cast on with the recommended selvedge cast on can have an uneven look to the edge. If knitting the ribbing after the garment (from the top down) is not for you, use a selvedge cast on with only two passes in the part position instead of the traditional three. You will have a much nicer, smoother edge of the ribbing.

### GET MORE OUT OF YOUR STITCH PATTERN CARTRIDGE EXTRAS!

The Stitch Pattern Extras Cartridge has over 800 patterns for use on any Compuknit knitting machine, as all patterns are no more than 24 stitches. When loading into the machine, you can use only the variation keys available on the individual machine. If you want to see the pattern on the Pattern Design Computer screen or use any part of the pattern in creating a new design, it is possible to do so using the following steps:

*For use with the DesignaKnit program:*

1. Load from the cartridge in the Pattern Design Computer into the IBM compatible and use the pattern in whatever method you desire within the DesignaKnit paint/color portion.

*For use with the Compuknit machines via the Pattern Design Computer:*

1. Load the desired pattern into the knitter from the Pattern Design Computer.
2. Transfer the pattern from the machine to the Floppy Disk Drive.
3. Use the Floppy Disk Drive in conjunction with the Pattern Design Computer to load any portion or all of the desired pattern from Volume 5 (Stitch Pattern Extras Cartridge) for use.

 With Col. 1 CO 74 (74) [80] sts. for K1/P1 Rib. After selvedge, RC 0. T 1/1 I. Knit to R 42. Transfer RB sts. to MB. Incr. 2 sts. on each side. RC 0. T 7. Knit in Lace Weaving Pattern while incr. on each side every 4 Rs. 1 St. 39x (every 4 Rs. 1 St. 39x) [every 4 Rs. 1 St. 40x]. At R 160 (166) [166] knit 1 row at T 10 and BOLT.

**NECKBAND:**  
 Join one shoulder first. With Col. 1 CO 146 (150) [154] sts. for K1/P1 Rib. After selvedge T 1/1 I. RC 0. Knit to R 16. Transfer RB sts. to MB. With purl side facing rehanging neckline on these ndls. as shown on chart. Knit 1 row at T 10 and BOLT.

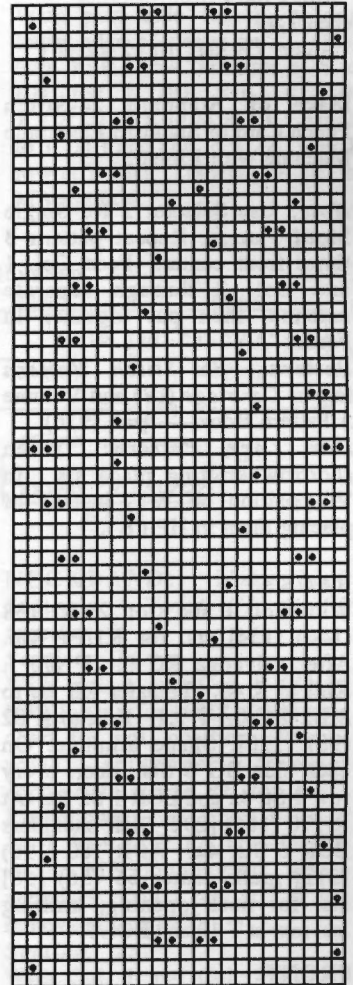

first row to form doubled band. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT. With purl side facing rehang right side of front neckline opening on 46 (56) ndls. RC 0. T 2.2. Col. 2. Knit to R 20. Pick up sts. from first row to form doubled band. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

**knit**ing *technical tips*

Having grown up in a household where electronics played a prominent part, I learned, at a very early age, that electricity is to be respected as one of the truly great powers of nature. As I got older, this respect became stronger each time I had a "close encounter" with Father Electricity. Yet, if I learned anything, it was that instructions are always to be followed to the letter when using electrical appliances. Of course, these days, Underwriter's Laboratories has made sure that we don't have to worry about electrocution anymore. But, we still have to use good, common sense so that the appliances themselves are not harmed by our oversights.

So, under the heading "An Ounce of Prevention is worth a Pound of Cure," I offer you these very simple rules when using the various Knitkting products that use electricity:

When using the Pattern Design Computer, Compuknit/Bulky, Compuknit/ST or CK-35, **always turn the power off** prior to putting the cartridge in or taking it out. This will insure that any ambient electrical activity will not "shock" the cartridge.

When connecting the Compuknit IV to either the Pattern Design Computer or the Floppy Disk Drive, again, **make sure the power is off**. Likewise for connecting the Pattern Design Computer to the Floppy Disk Drive.

When using the DesignaKnit Knitwear Design Computer Program, **make sure to turn off the Pattern Design Computer (or Compuknit IV) when attaching the Cable Link Interface. This is especially true on the Pattern Design Computer, as the transfer will often not even work unless the PDC is turned off first.**

Finally, many so-called "problems" we handle surrounding the electronic machines and accessories are completely avoided by using a **Surge Protector** in-between the wall socket of your home and the knitting machine product. **Surge Protectors** are generally strips of six AC outlets with a circuit breaker built-in to act as a buffer for electrical surges caused by a variety of things inside and outside of your home. If you're not using one now, please do. They are available through Knitkting and its dealers.
