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
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# editorial

#### **KNITKING MAGAZINE TO DOUBLE IN SIZE ...!**

If we accepted advertising from other companies, our income per issue would increase, but KNITKING MAGAZINE has never wanted outside advertising ... in fact, we have turned away what could be a source of revenue in order that our publication be devoted entirely to machine knitting ... KNITKING MAGA-ZINE completes its 10th year of publication with this issue and we have never made a penny profit on it ... We think it unfair to sell knitting machines without providing pattern instructions ... KNITKING is a progressive company that believes in service to its customers ... As we grow, so do our services ... Our readers have been saying that they want more patterns and we have now worked out a way they can get them at an absolute minimum cost ... Additionally, there will be several sizes for each pattern . . . All sizes will use the same yarn and each size will have its own set of charts. By publishing the magazine 6 times a year at twice the present size, we can substantially reduce the cost per pattern ... For twice the magazine with many more costly color pages our subscription rate will only increase \$3.00, from \$7.00 to \$10.00 per year .. (\$12.00 to Canadian subscribers. The extra \$2.00 only covers mailing costs) ... from a subscription rate calculated at 1,166 dollars per issue, it will increase to 1.666 dollars per issue . . Less than half as much again .... Approximately 250 patterns per year for \$10.00 or 25 top quality machine knit patterns for \$1.00 .... Isn't that an incredible bargain . .? 



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

DK 8336 – Tour any town wearing this pretty Pullover and Skirt. Knit the Top in a Holding Position Design with bands in a 1 x 1 Rib. The Skirt is in Stockinette stitch. If you do not own a Ribber, use a Mock Rib for the bands. Sizes 12, 14 and 16.



DK 8345 — A softly shaped Blouse has a most flattering neckline. The full sleeves are gathered onto a band at the wrist. Perfect for now . . . or anytime. An easy knit Pattern in Stockinette stitch. Sizes 14, 16 and 18.


DK 8339 – Show off a summer tan in a bare and breezy halter Top. The rib effect is really a Holding Position Design using Silver Metallic combined with the main yarn. The wide legged Pants are knitted in Stockinette stitch. In Sizes 8, 10 and 12.



P 3694 — A different look or a Sport Shirt (or Cardigan) striped at the yoke and on the sleeves and pockets. A comfortable addition to your tan's travel wardrobe. Sizes 0, 44 and 46.


# COCKTAIL TIME

DK 8341 — Put sparkle into your life with a simple to knit — yet elegant dress when it's made with Beatrice Silver. A shell crochet trims the neckline and sleeve edges . . . or you might like to knit your own trim then sew it on. Sizes 10, 12 and 14.

**DK 8350** – Summer Romantics . . . A dream of a long Stole for all enchanted evenings. Knit it in a Norwegian Design using Beatrice Silver and Monofil. KG 1983 — For sun seekers everywhere . . . If you are Bikini minded (and who isn't) you will want all three styles. Numbers 1 and 2 are knitted in Stockinette stitch with style Number 3 in a Holding Position Design. All are made with Amore. Sizes 10, 12 and 14.

# FUNCSUNTIME

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KG 1982 — Whip up a swinging Tote Bag (or two). Both are in a Weaving Design. You can use your JAC 40 or follow the Line Drawing. Line them with a firm fabric and sew tassels at each lower corner.



The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Holding Position Design with every 6th needle out of work. Follow the Line Drawing. The Purl side is the right side. KNITKING machine owners may use Cam Wheel No. 6 for Rows 1-2, 5-6 etc., and the Adjustable Needle Selector for Rows 3-4, 7-8 etc., and push down the LEFT Retractor Button and leave it there for Pattern. INCREASES: Move the end st. 1 needle outward and pick up a stitch from the row below. DECREASES: Hang the end st. onto the next needle. EDGES: Stockinette stitch. To form the hem, hang the cast on stitches back onto the machine behind the latches, then knit the following row with 1 or 2 tension settings higher.

FINISHING: Block all sections. Join side seams, easing in the fullness at bustline of front section. Sew sleeves together and set in. Sew short ends of neckband together, then sew 1 edge to inside and 1 to the outside of neckline.

Bring the needles on the left side into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left, turn the Row Counter back to 398 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from<sup>\*</sup>.

\*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Row 398 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 3 sts. after Row 399 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 2 sts. after Row 400; 3 sts. after Row 401; 2 sts. after Row 402, 403, 404, 405, 406, 407, 408; 1 st. after Row 409; 2 sts. after Row 410; 1 st. after Row 411; 2 sts. after Row 412; 1 st. after Row 413; 2 sts. after Row 412; 1 st. after Row 415; 3 sts. after Row 414; 1 st. after Row 415; 3 sts. after Row 416; 1 st. after Row 418; 2 sts. after Row 417; 3 sts. after Rows 418, 420.


ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 254, 255, 258, 259; 3 sts. after Rows 262, 263, 266, 267; 2 sts. after Rows 270, 271, 274, 275; 1 st. after Rows 278, 279, 282, 283, 286, 287, then knit to Row 398. Bind off the center 31 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 132, 148, 164, 180, 196, 212, 228, 242, then knit to Row 254 (276 for front section).

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 32, 42, 52, 62, 72, 82, 92, 102, then knit to Row 132.

ROWS 0 to 32: Knit even, then hang the hem and start the Holding Position Design.

Cast on 161 sts. and work Stockinette stitch.



Cast on 179 sts. and work 14 rows Stockinette stitch then bind off all sts.


Bring the needles on the left side into working position, knit 1 row to the left in Pattern, turn the Row Counter back to 340 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from\*

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 420 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING) 422, 424, 426, 428, 430, 432, 434, 346; 3 sts. after Rows 438, 440, 442.

\*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 341, 343 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 2 sts. after Rows 345, 347; 1 st. after Rows 349, 351, 353, 355, 361, 367, 373, 379, 385, 391, then knit to Row 420.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 276, 277, 280, 281; 3 sts. after Rows 284, 285, 288, 289; 2 sts. after Rows 292, 293, 296, 297; 1 st. after Rows 300, 301, 304, 305, 308, 309, then knit to Row 340, bind off the center 25 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

Work the Front section the same as the Back section to Row 276.




ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 4 sts. after Rows 96, 97, 100, 101; 3 sts. after Rows 104, 105, 108, 109, 112, 113; 2 sts. after Rows 116, 117, 120, 121; 1 st. after Rows 124, 125; 2 sts. after Rows 128, 129; 1 st. after Rows 132, 133; 2 sts. after Rows 136, 137; 1 st. after sts. after Rows 136, 137; 1 st. after Rows 140, 141; 2 sts. after Rows 144, 145; 1 st. after Rows 148, 149; 2 sts. after Rows 152, 153; 1 st. after Rows 156, 157; 2 sts. after Rows 160, 161; 1 st. after Rows 164, 165; 2 sts. after Rows 159, 1 st. after Rows 172 Rows 168, 169; 1 st. after Rows 172, 173; 2 sts. after Rows 176, 177; 3 sts. after Rows 180, 181, 184, 185; 4 sts. after Rows 188, 189; 11 sts. after Row 190.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 32, 40, 48, 56, 64, 72, 80, 88, then knit to Row 96.

ROWS 0 to 32: Knit even, then hang the hem and change to the Holding position Design.








The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Skirt and Sleeves: Stockinette stitch. PULLOVER front and back: Holding position Design as in the Line Drawing. Use the Adjustable Needle Selector and Cam Wheel No. 2. Worn on the Purl side. EDGES: K1, P1 Ribbing. DECREASES: Skirt: Hang the 4th st. onto the 3rd needle then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. INCREASES: Move the 2nd end sts. 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. SKIRT: Weave the sections together 1 st. in from each edge. Turn under 22 rows on lower edge and 13 rows at upper edge and hem to wrong side. Insert an elastic band into the upper hem. PULLOVER: Join front and back sections at sides and shoulders. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Join the Neckband and sew 1 edge to the neckline.



The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Stockinette stitch worn on the knit side. INCREASES: Move the 2 end sts. 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below onto the empty needle. DECREASES: Hang the 3rd st. onto the 2nd st. then move the end sts. 1 needle inward to fill the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. Join front and back sections at sides and shoulders. Sew the sleeves together and set in. Join the neckbands together and sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neckline. Gather bottom edge of sleeves. Sew 1 edge of band to the inside and 1 to the outside of sleeve. Turn under 15 rows on lower edge and hem.





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

Cast on 58 sts. and work 14 rows Stockinette stitch, then bind off all sts.



Bring the needles on the left side into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left, turn the Row Counter back to 260 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from\*.

\*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 261, 263 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 2 sts. after Rows 265, 267; 1 st. after Rows 269, 271, 273, 275, 277, then knit even to Row 300. Bind off 2 sts. after Rows 300 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 2 sts. after Rows 302, 304, 306, 308, 310, 312; 3 sts. after Rows 314, 316, 318.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 188, 189, 190, 191; 2 sts. after Rows 192, 193, 194, 195; 1 st. after Rows 196, 197, 198, 199, 200, 201, then knit to Row 260, bind off the center 13 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

#### ROWS 170 to 188: Knit even.

Work the front section the same as the back section to Row 170.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 190, 191, 192, 193, 194, 195; 2 sts. after Rows 196, 197, 198, 199; 1 st. after Rows 200 THROUGH 241; 2 sts. after Rows 242, 243; 5 sts. after Rows 244, 245, 246, 247; 16 sts. after Row 248.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 36, 44, 52, 60, 68, 76, 82, 90, 98, 106, 114, 122, 128, 134, 140, 146, 152, 158, 164, 170, 176, 182, then knit to Row 190.

ROWS 0 to 36: Knit even, then change to Stockinette stitch.

Cast on 64 sts. and work K1, P1 Ribbing.

R 14 front neckband with Is 3x is 3x 7"-71/2"-8" 0000 58sts

Cast on 58 sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Work the same as Back Neckband following the instructions from\*.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 212 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from \*.


ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 254, 256; 4 sts. after Rows 258, 260, 262, 264, 266, 268.

\*ROWS 212 to 254: Knit even.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 164, 165, 166, 167, 168, 169; 2 sts. after Rows 170, 171, 172, 173, 174, 175; 1 st. after Rows 176, 177, 178, 179, 180, 181, then knit to Row 212, bind off the center 58 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 5 needles after Rows 130, 131, 132, 133, 134, 135, 136, 137, 138, 139, 140, 141, 142, 143. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring all the needles back into working position after Rows 144, 145, then knit even to Row 164.

Work the Front section the same as the Back section to Row 130, then work Short Rows for the DARTS.

Bring the needles on the left side into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 282 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from\*.



ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 170, 171, 172, 173; 2 sts. after Rows 174, 175, 176, 177; 1 st. after Rows 178, 179, 180, 181, 182, 183; then knit to Row 282, bind off the center 19 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ROWS 37 to 170: Knit even.

ROWS 0 to 36: Knit even, then work Pattern stitch.

Cast on 115 sts. and work K1, P1 Ribbing.



Cast on 166 sts. and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off all sts. the crochet method for Ribbing.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 44, 52, 60, 68, 76, 84, 92, 100, 108, 116, 124, 132, 140, 148, 156, 164, 172, 180, 188, 196, 204, 212, 220, 228, 236, 242, 248, 254, 260, 266, then knit to Row 294. Bind off the remaining 64 sts. Work 3 more sections the same.

ROWS 0 to 44: Knit even.

Cast on 124 sts. and work Stockinette stitch.

\*ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Row 240 (EVEN ROWS = SHOULDER SHAPING); 3 sts. after Row 241 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 3 sts. after Rows 242, 243; 4 sts. after Row 244; 3 sts. after Row 245; 4 sts. after Row 246; 3 sts. after Row 247; 4 sts. after Row 246; 3 sts. after Row 249; 4 sts. after Row 248; 3 sts. after Row 249; 4 sts. after Row 250; 3 sts. after Row 251; 4 sts. after Rows 252, 254.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Rows 148, 149, 150, 151, 152, 153; 2 sts. after Rows 154, 155, 156, 157, 158, 159; 1 st. after Rows 160, 161, 162, 163, 164, 165, then knit to Row 240, bind off the center 22 sts., put the needles on the left side into holding position and complete the right half first.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 54, 64, 74, 84, 94, 104, 114, 124, then knit to Row 148.



Cast on 138 sts. and work Stockinette stitch.

The instructions are the same for all sizes. PATTERN: Pants: Stockinette stitch. TOP: Stockinette stitch and a Holding Position Design worked in 2 colors according to the Line Drawing. DECREASES: Hang the 3rd st. onto the 2nd st., then move the end sts. inward to fill the empty needle. INCREASES: Move the 2 end sts. 1 needle outward, then place the 3rd st. from the row below onto the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. PANTS: Join the front and back sections at sides. Sew the inner leg seams together. Join the sections at center back and center front. Turn under 22 rows on leg edges and 11 rows on upper edge and hem to the wrong side. Insert an elastic band into the upper hem. TOP: Join the back and front sections at sides. With Color 2, make trimming to go around neck edge and around armholes and back edging as follows: Cast on 7 sts. and with Tension 1, knit in Stockinette stitch until long enough to go around neck edge. Bind off. Sew 1 edge to outside and 1 edge to inside. Make another piece long enough to go around both armhole edges and across back. Crochet ends of straps making a loop on one and sew a button onto the other.



Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 216 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from\*.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 2 sts. after Rows 345, 347, 349, 351.

Knit even to Row 126 (130) (134). Remove the 12 sts. onto contrast waste yarn. Put one side into working position, pick up each knot st. along side of the 12 sts. held on contrast and knit 24 rows. Form hem and bind off. Bring the other side into working position, pick up each knot st. along other side. Knit 24 rows, form hem and bind off all sts.

FINISHING: Pants: Join back and front by weaving the center sts. held on contrast and the leg bands. Insert elastic in waist and legs.

DECREASES: Place the 3rd st. onto the 2 nd st. then move the sts. over to fill the empty needle.

FINISHING: Block all sections. SWEATER; Join fronts and back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Join the front bands and sew in place. Finish buttonholes and sew on buttons. Sew 1 edge of neckband to the inside and 1 to the outside of neckline.

on buttons. Sew 1 edge of neckband to the inside and 1 to the outside of neckline. BONNET: Weave the sts. of the crown together, then remove contrast waste yarn. Sew back seam of hat, then sew to crown. Make 2 pom-poms and 2 cords. Sew pom-poms to each end of cord with other end of cord to the bonnet. Booties: Weave the sts. together that are held on contrast waste yarn, then sew seams.



Continue to decrease 1 st. ON EACH SIDE after Rows 66, 70, 74, 78, 82, 88, then ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. EVERY OTHER ROW 26 x more. After Row 144, bind off the remaining 27 sts.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 32, 38, 44, 50, 54, 58, 62, then begin PATTERN after Row 66.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put 30 needles into holding position after Rows 20 and 21. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position 6 needles after Rows 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31.

ROWS 0 to 20: Knit even, then work Short Rows.

Cast on 105 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.

Cast on 74 sts. with color 1 and work 20 rows Stockinette stitch, making BUTTONHOLES after Row 5 over needles 11 and 12, 23 and 24, 35 and 36 counting from the RIGHT and again over the SAME needles after Row 15. After Row 20, bind off all sts. make another band the same but OMIT the buttonholes.

Work the second Front section with reverse shaping, casting on from RIGHT to LEFT. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 3 sts. after Row 125 (ODD ROWS = NECK SHAPING); 1 st. after Row 126; 2 sts. after Row 127; 1 st. after Rows 128, 129, 130, 131, 132, 133, 134, 135, 136, 137.

ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 66, 70, 74, 78, 82, 88, then EVERY OTHER ROW 18x more. (Row 124).

ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st, after Rows 32, 38, 44, 50, 54, 58, 62, then begin PATTERN after Row 66.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put 30 needles into holding position. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position, 6 needles after Rows 23, 25, 27, 29, 31.

ROWS 0 to 21: Knit even, then work Short Rows.


Cast on 50 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.


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
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

Work the second sleeve section with reverse shaping, casting on from right to left. Cam Box will be on the LEFT side at Row 0.

Continue to decrease 1 st. ON CAM BOX SIDE and work Short Rows OPPOSITE CAM BOX. Decrease 1 st. ON CAM BOX SIDE after Row 152, put 3 needles OPPOSITE CAM BOX into HOLDING POSITION; decrease 1 st. ON CAM BOX SIDE after Row 154, put 3 needles OPPOSITE CAM BOX into holding position; decrease 1 st. ON CAM BOX SIDE after Row 156, put 3 needles OPPOSITE CAM BOX into holding position. After Row 158, bring all the needles back into working position and bind off all sts.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. after Rows 102, 106, 110, 114, then every other row to Row 152.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 80, 90, then knit to Row 102.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. after Rows 20, 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, then begin PATTERN after Row 80. ROWS 0 to 20: K nit even.

Cast on 45 sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 2 needles after Rows 102, 103, 104, 105, 106, 107, 108, 109. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position 2 needles after Rows 110, 111, 112, 113, 114, 115, 116, 117. After Row 118, remove the stitches onto a stitch holder (contrast waste yarn).

ROWS 72 to 102: Knit even, then work Short Rows.

ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position, 2 needles after Rows 56, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 62, 63. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position 2 needles after Rows 64, 65, 66, 67, 68, 69, 70, 71.

ROWS 25 to 56: Knit even, then change to Stockinette stitch and work Short Rows.

ROWS 21 to 24: Knit even, then remove 20 sts. on the RIGHT side (left for second bootie) onto a stitch holder (contrast waste yarn) and begin the PATTERN Design.

ROWS 0 to 20: Knit even, then change to Stockinette stitch.

Cast on 40 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing.

ROWS 26 to 66: Knit 4 rows color 1; 32 Rows PATTERN, then 4 Rows color 1. After Row 66, bind off all sts.


ROWS 0 to 26: Knit even, then change to Stockinette stitch and PATTERN Design.

Cast on 102 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing.



\*Knit 2 rows, then work Short Rows. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 2 needles after Rows 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18. After Row 20, bring all the needles into working position and REPEAT from \* 8x more, ending with 1 row over all needles then remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.

With contrast waste yarn, cast on 20 sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit 8 to 10 rows, change to color 1, put Row Counter to 0 and continue Stockinette stitch with Short Rows.



# Knitking New

#### PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS DOUBLED NECK AND ARMHOLE BANDS

Many of our garments have a doubled neckband and armhole band where 1 edge is sewn to the inside and 1 to the outside of neckline or armhole. If you will change Tensions when knitting bands of this type, you will find they will fit better. For instance, the Dress and Jacket DK 8342 in this issue have doubled neckbands. The Jacket neckband has 50 rows. If you are using Tension 5 for the Jacket, you will begin and end the knitting of the neckband with this tension... so.. after casting on the specified number of stitches, knit 10 rows Tension 5, 10 rows Tension 4, 10 rows Tension 3, 10 rows Tension 4, 10 rows Tension 5. Now when you sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside, the neckband will hug the neck nicely. Do the same with the Dress neckband... Knit 4 rows Tension 5, 4 rows Tension 4, 6 rows Tension 3, 4 rows Tension 4, 4 rows Tension 5; the total of 22 rows needed for the band.

You can do this with ANY doubled neckband or armhole band and it can be used for doubled cuffs on a sleeve as well.

#### KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE

More and more knitters are discovering our CONVERTA TAPE and its many applications... Designed originally for the purpose of charting custom knits, it has a multitude of other uses. When used for charting knits, it is extremely simple to use in conjunction with the special Stitch and Row Gauge Faper available from KNITKING (8 sheets for \$2.00 plus 20¢ mailing costs).

The wide space at the end of the Tape is for taking a stitch (or row) gauge. To count the stitches (or rows) in the two inches, you set the sliding window (as shown in the illustration) over the number 14, then using the tape you measure the person for whom you are knitting a garment. Whatever the measurement is, you just look down at the number the pointer window is pointing to and that is the exact number of stitches or rows you need. Everbody at some time has trouble counting stitches and rows... Some yarns and some colors make it difficult to see individual stitches especially when fancy stitches or fancy yarns are used. In the following Knitting Hint, we tell you how (using a CONVERTA TAPE) to obtain a perfect count WITHOUT COUNTING.....

#### THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 2 inches (5 cm).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 Tension Numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows WITHOUT actually counting by using our KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast-on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn, then remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the figuring for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows...



To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast yarn. Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the tape. Your stitch gauge to 2 inches will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 2 inches, place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for two inches will show in the red window.... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 2 inch square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

# NOTES TO KNIT BY . .

#### STITCH AND ROW GAUGE

KNIT A SAMPLE SWATCH... before you begin to knit any garment... for this is the MOST IMPORTANT STEP toward the correct size and the proper fit of any garment you wish to make. You MUST use the SAME YARN for your sample swatch that you will use to knit your garment and your sample swatch must be knitted large enough and using several different tension numbers on your machine. When you have done this, then you can determine the number of stitches and the number of rows in a two-inch measure. KNITKING MAGAZINE PATTERNS give you 3 tensions to try and one of them should give you the correct stitch and row gauge if you are using the yarn we recommend or a similar weight yarn. Here is the way to make your sample swatch.

Cast on over a sufficient number of needles to produce a swatch at least 4 inches wide. (If the pattern calls for 16 stitches to 2", then  $16 \times 2 = 32$  stitches to cast on). Now knit 4 inches of rows at the first suggested tension number. (If the pattern calls for 22 rows to 2",  $22 \times 2 = 44$  rows to knit). Knit 2 rows using a contrast color, change to the next higher tension and with garment yarn knit another 4", knit 2 rows with contrast color, change to the 3rd higher tension and knit another 4" and then bind off.

Roll the swatch into a cylinder over its length and pull on both ends, unroll it and stretch it diagonally by pulling on the four corners. Allow the swatch to rest and settle (preferably overnight) and then using a stitch gauge or a ruler, count the number of stitches over a 2" width, then the number of rows over a 2" length in EACH of the 3 tensions. Select the tension number that produces the stitches and rows called for in the pattern. If none of them are correct, you are most likely using the wrong weight of yarn.

#### **READING OF CHARTS**

You will notice the instructions start at the bottom of the Chart, and work UP. Follow the charts exactly as written and providing your sample stitch and row gauge is correct, your garment will come out the right size. Please remember that the section of garment as it is knitted on the machine, faces the same way as the Charts are in this magazine. Where two front pieces are needed, (or any other part of a garment that needs two sections) only one section is normally shown and the second section is usually made with reverse shaping. Set in sleeves are usually identical, but raglan sleeves have to be knitted with reverse shaping for the second sleeve.

#### **READING OF SYMBOLS**

To simplify Pattern Knitting, we use Symbols in the Line Drawings and the Chart Diagrams. In the Line Drawings the symbols are shown and are to be read as you look at them while knitting a garment. For instance, if a Purl stitch faces you, the Purl stitch Symbol is shown; if a knit stitch faces you (as when using the Ribber) then this Symbol is shown. The Symbol at the top of the Line Drawing is the center of the garment section and you use this as a guide for setting up the needles.

The following Symbols  $\square$  are used for Eyelet Designs in the Line Drawings and also for Full Fashion shaping on the Charts. The Line Drawings have row numbers on the right side. Missing Row numbers are always knitted straight or plain.

In Holding Position Designs selected needles are pushed into holding position for the stated number of rows. The numbers of rows appear at the right of the Line Drawings; Example: 1-4 means knit Rows 1 to 4; 5 to 7 means knit Rows 5 to 7, etc. This same Symbol is also shown on the Charts and is used for putting needles into holding position for Short Rows. The

Symbol Symbol on the Charts is used to put needles back into working position when knitting Short Rows.


A number in a box stands for the number of rows to be knitted between shapings. Make shaping first, then knit the necessary number of rows. If for instance it reads: 1 st, 8 x



As you will be reading the instructions from the bottom up, here is the way you will follow them: . . . Decrease or increase (depending on the direction of the garment outline) 1 st. at the row where the shaping begins, then knit 8 rows, make the next decrease, then knit 8 rows, until you have decreased (or increased) 1 st. 10 x and you have knitted 8 rows after each decrease (or increase) 1 st. 10 x +8 rows 10 x). Now begin the first decrease (or increase) for the shaping (which has to be made 8 x) in every 6th row. Decrease (or increase) 1 st. first, then knit 6 rows until you have decreased 1 st. 6 x and after each decrease (or increase) have knitted 6 rows until you have decrease 1 st. 6 x and after each decrease (or increase) have knitted 6 rows (1 st. 8 x + 6 rows 8 x).

Where shapings are given without a boxed number as on most armholes, necklines, etc., make the shapings on every second row (on each side of course).
