All decreasing (or increasing) without row numbers as shown must be shaped on every 2nd row.

 Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.
-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
 Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.

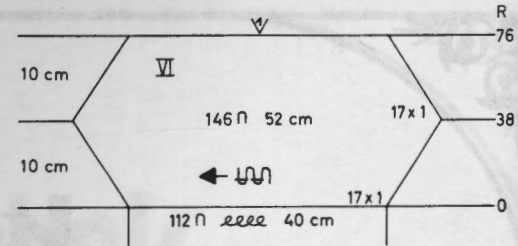
WOMAN'S JACKET & SKIRT

SIZE: 8/10 (12/14) [16]
 YARN: Combinella Fina
 GRAMS: 1200 1250 1300
 TENSION: 7 to 9
 GAUGE: 14 sts. 19 rows = 5 cm (2")



Both Jacket & skirt are knitted sideways on the machine with the Purl side the right side.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. SKIRT: Weave the open sts. together then remove the waste yarn. JACKET: Sew 1 edge of Cuffs to inside and 1 to outside of sleeve edge, easing to fit.



COLLAR: VI

Cast on 112 sts. and work Stockinette stitch.
 ON EACH SIDE, cast on 1 st. 17x.
 After Row 38, ON EACH SIDE, bind off 1 st. 17x. After Row 76, bind off the remaining sts.

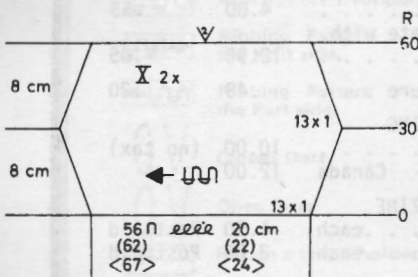
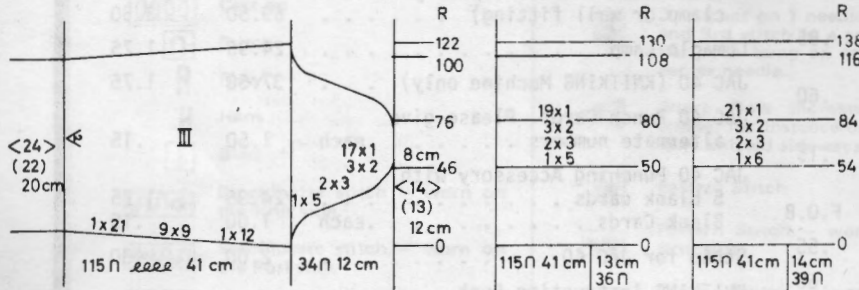
SLEEVE: III

Cast on 115 sts. and work Stockinette stitch and SHORT ROWS.
 ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put 114 sts. into holding position, knit 2 rows. ON THE RIGHT, cast on 5 (5) [6] sts. and ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position
 12 sts. 1x, 9 sts. 9x, 21 sts. 1x, AND AT THE SAME TIME, on every 2nd row, cast on 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 17x (19x) [21x].
 Knit to Row 76 (80) [84].
 ON CAM BOX SIDE, bind off 1 st. 17x (19x) [21x], 2 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 2x, 5 (5) [6] sts. 1x and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 100 (108) [116], ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 21 sts. 1x, 9 sts. 9x, 12 sts. 1x.
 After Row 122 (130) [138], bring all the needles into working position and bind off loosely.

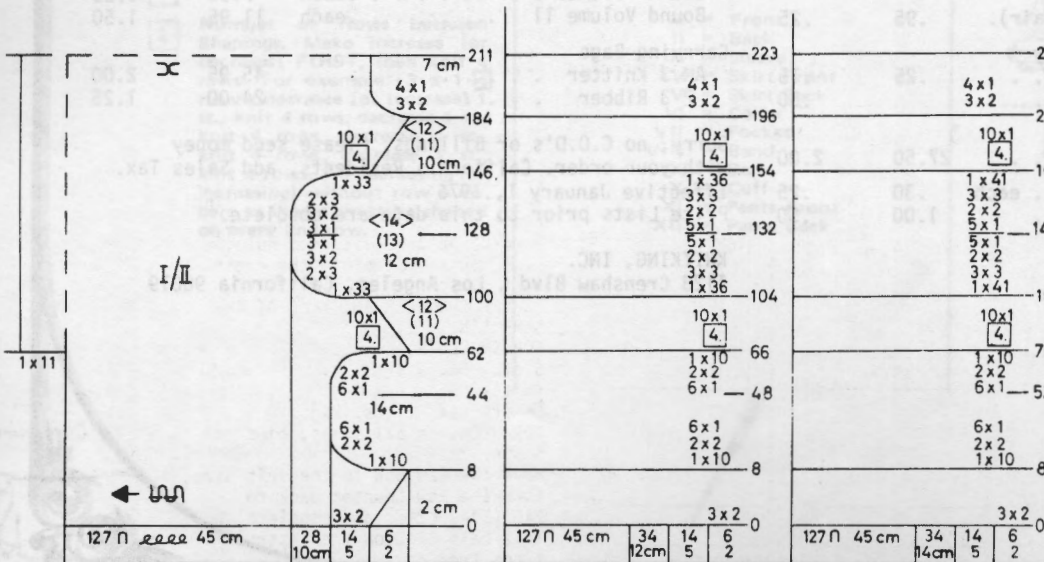

 ON THE RIGHT side, on every 2nd row, cast on 2 sts. 3x.
 After Row 8, bind off 10 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 6x.
 Knit to Row 44 (48) [52].
 Cast on 1 st. 6x, 2 sts. 2x, 10 sts. 1x.
 After Row 62, (66) [70], with a separate yarn, cast on 11 sts. on the LEFT side and ON THE RIGHT side, bind off 1 st. every 4th row 10x.
 After Row 100 (104) [108], bind off 33 (36) [41] sts., then bind off 3 sts. 2x (3x) [3x], 2 sts. 3x (2x) [2x], 1 st. 3x (5x) [5x].
 Knit to Row 128 (132) [140].
 Cast on 1 st. 3x (5x) [5x], 2 sts. 3x (2x) [2x], 3 sts. 2x (3x) [3x], 33 (36) [41] sts. 1x.
 After Row 146 (154) [162], cast on 1 st. every 4th row 10x.
 After Row 184 (196) [208], bind off 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 4x.
 Knit to Row 211 (223) [235]
 THIS IS THE CENTER BACK OF JACKET and you must now WORK BACKWARDS. Begin by knitting 15 rows, then cast on 1 st. 4x, 2 sts. 3x, etc. It will be easier for you to follow the Chart.

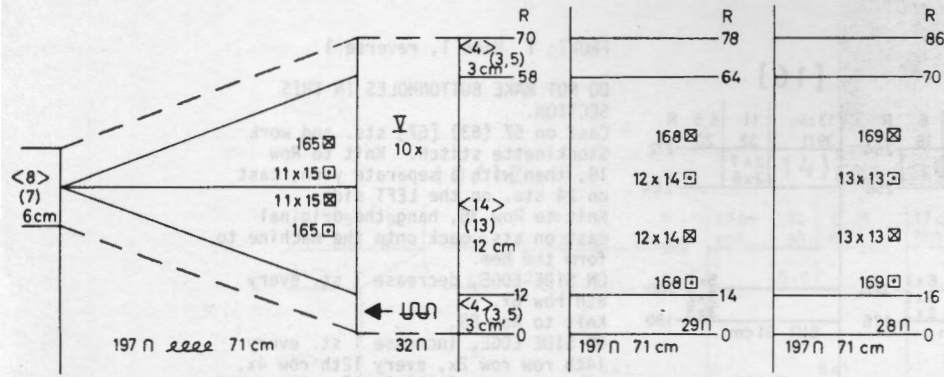

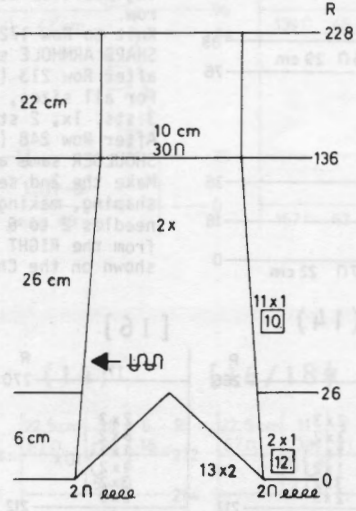

 *Knit to Row 12 (14) [16].
 ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 165 (168) [169] sts.
 ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, bring back into working position, 15 (14) [13] sts. 11x (12x) [13x].
 ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 15 (14) [13] sts. 11x (12x) [13x].
 Bring all the needles back into working position and knit to Row 70 (78) [86].*
 Turn the Row Counter to 0 and REPEAT from * to * 9x more.
 Remove the sts. onto contrast waste yarn.



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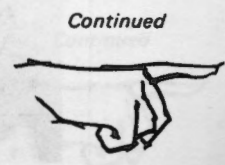
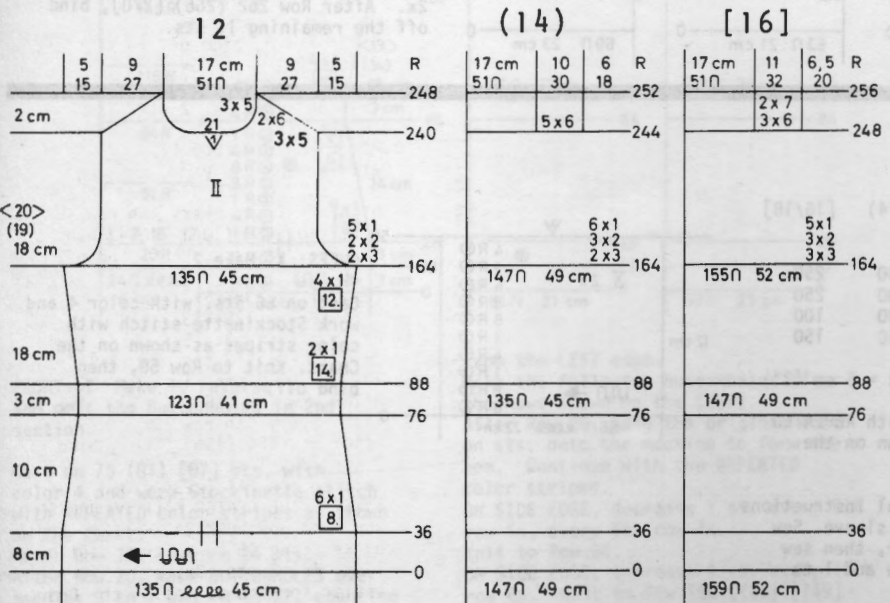

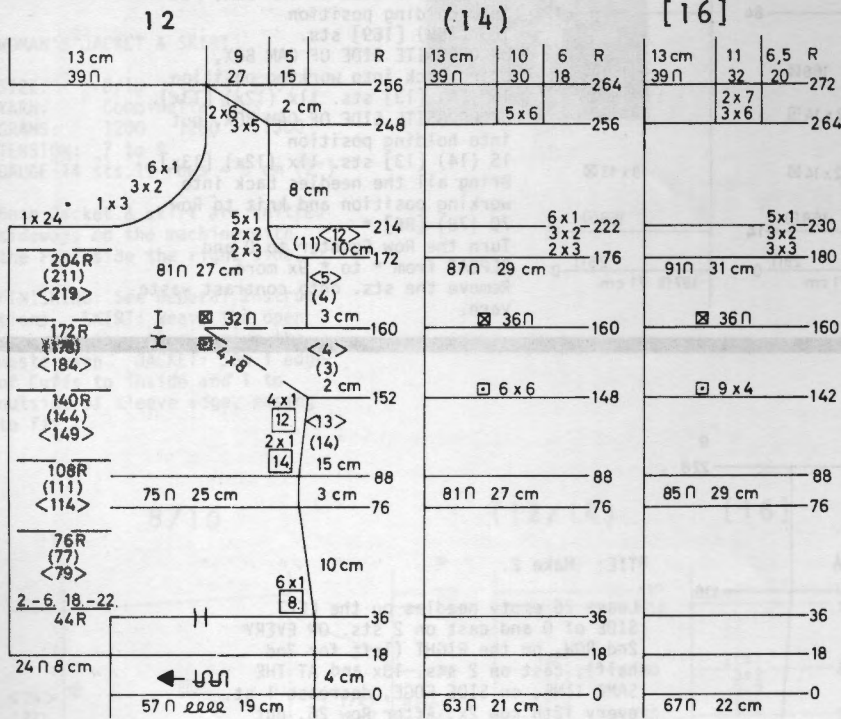
TIE: Make 2.
 Leave 26 empty needles on the LEFT SIDE of 0 and cast on 2 sts. ON EVERY 2nd ROW, on the RIGHT (left for 2nd half), cast on 2 sts. 13x and AT THE SAME TIME, on SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 12th row 2x. After Row 26, put these needles into holding position. Leave 26 empty needles to the right of 0, then cast on 2 sts. ON THE LEFT side, cast on 2 sts. 13x, and ON CAM BOX SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 12th row 2x. After Row 26, bring all the needles into working position. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 10th row 11x. Knit to Row 228. Bind off.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.
 Sew the straight edges of Tie together, fold in half and sew up the ends leaving an opening to fit around neckline. Turn to the right side, pin then sew 1 edge to the outside and 1 to the inside of neck edge.

BACK: II
 Cast on 135 (147) [159] sts. and work Stockinette stitch.
 Knit to Row 36. Hang the hem.
 ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 8th row 6x.
 Knit to Row 88.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 2x, every 12th row 4x.
 Knit to Row 164.
SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off
 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x). [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x].
 Knit to Row 240 (244) [248]. Bind off the center 21 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.
***SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.**
FOR SHOULDER, bind off
 5 sts. 3x, 6 sts. 2x. (6 sts. 5x). [6 sts. 3x, 7 sts. 2x].
FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off
 5 sts. 3x.
 Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 240 (244) [248] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

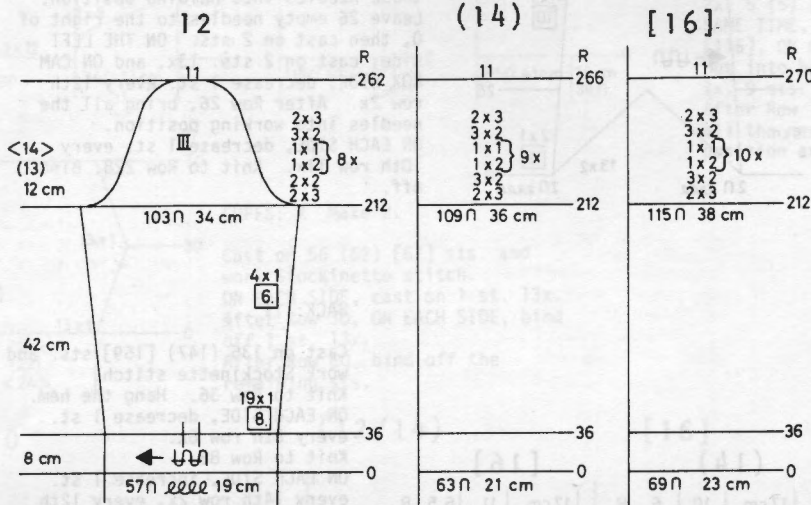


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FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

DO NOT MAKE BUTTONHOLES IN THIS SECTION.
 Cast on 57 (63) [67] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 18, then with a separate yarn, cast on 24 sts. on the LEFT side. Knit to Row 36, hang the original cast on sts. back onto the machine to form the hem.
 ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 8th row 6x.
 Knit to Row 88.
 ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 14th row 2x, every 12th row 4x. After Row 151 (147) [141], work SHORT ROWS for the BUST DART. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 8 sts. 4x (6 sts. 6x) [4 sts. 9x]. Bring all the needles back into working position before knitting the next row.
 Knit to Row 172 (176) [180].
 SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back and after Row 213 (221) [229], SHAPE NECK. For all sizes, bind off 24 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x. After Row 248 (256) [264], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.
 Make the 2nd section with reverse shaping, making BUTTONHOLES over needles 2 to 6 and 18 to 22 counting from the RIGHT EDGE after the Rows shown on the Chart for YOUR SIZE.



SLEEVE: III

Cast on 57 (63) [69] sts. and work Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 36, then hang the hem.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 19x, every 6th row 4x. Knit to Row 212.
 SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x (3x) [3x], *2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 1x and REPEAT from * 7x (8x) [9x] more, 2 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 2x. After Row 262 (266) [270], bind off the remaining 11 sts.

YARN: Beatrice

GRAMS:

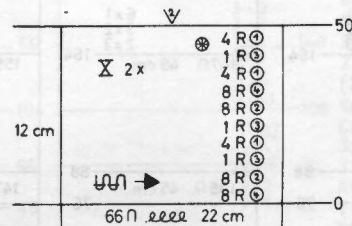

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Gather lower edge of sleeve. Sew ends of Cuff together, then sew 1 edge to the outside and 1 to inside of sleeve.



CUFFS: X Make 2.

Cast on 66 sts. with color 4 and work Stockinette stitch with color stripes as shown on the Chart. Knit to Row 50, then bind off.

Cast on 145 (157) [169] sts. with color 4 and work Stockinette stitch with REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart.

Knit to Row 26, then hang the hem.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 8th row 5x, every 6th row 4x. Knit to Row 96.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 18th row 4x. Knit to Row 172.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off

3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x). [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x]. Knit to Row 248 (252) [256].

Bind off the center 21 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

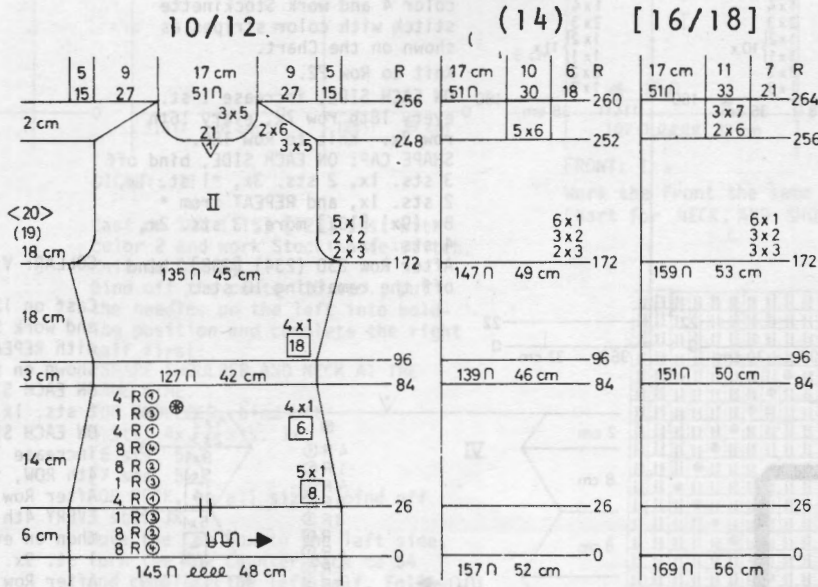

5 sts. 3x, 6 sts. 2x. (6 sts. 5x).

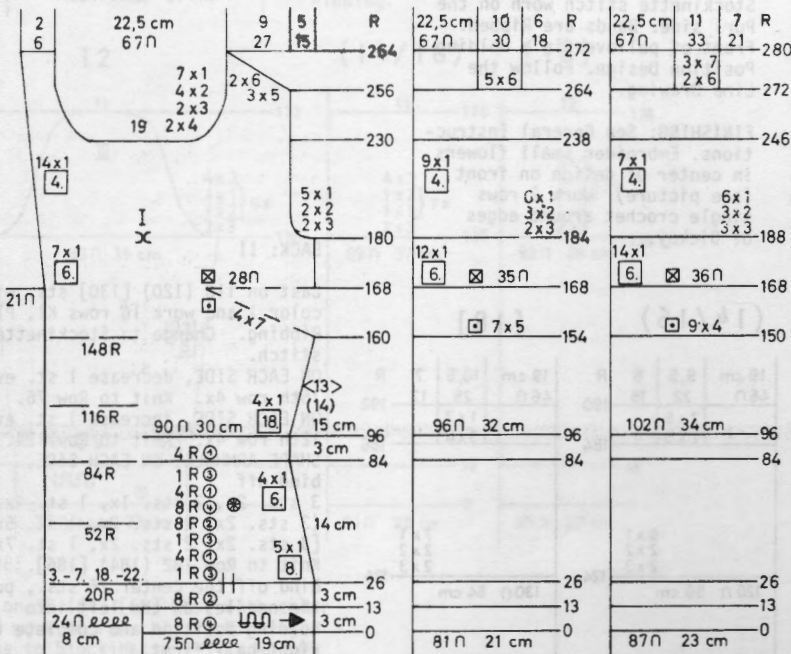

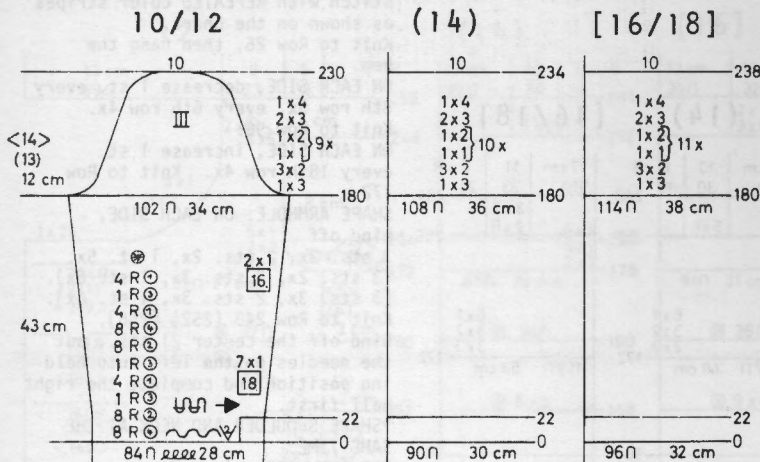

After Row 230 (234) [238], bind off the remaining 10 sts.

COLLAR: VI

Cast on 126 sts. with color 4 and work Stockinette stitch with REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart.

ON EACH SIDE, bind off

2 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 2x.

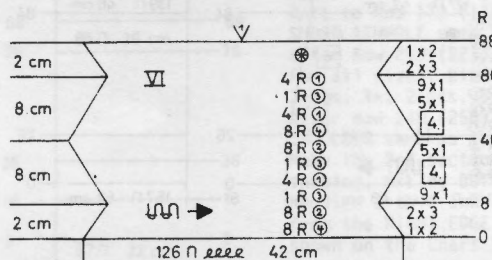

YARN: color 1 - Alanda
color 2 - Regia

GRAMS:

TENSION: color 1 - 10
color 2 - 5 to 7

GAUGE:
color 1 12 sts. 15 rows = 5 cm
color 2 16 sts. 21 rows = 5 cm
Scraps of red and blue for embroidery.

Stockinette stitch worn on the Purl side. Bands are Ribbed. Front of pullover in a Holding Position Design. Follow the Line Drawing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions. Embroider small flowers in center of design on front (see picture). Work 2 rows single crochet around edges of Dickey.



BACK: II

Cast on 110 (120) [130] sts. with color 1 and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch.

ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 16th row 4x. Knit to Row 76.

ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 12th row 4x. Knit to Row 124.

SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off

3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 5x).

[3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 7x]. Knit to Row 182 (184) [186].

Bind off the center 26 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

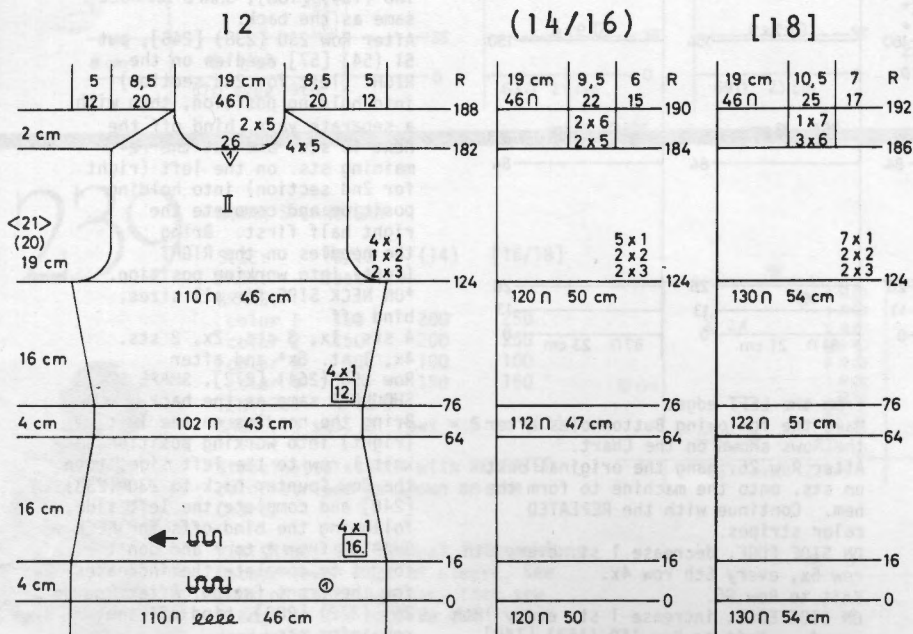
*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off 5 sts. 4x.

ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 14x (12x) [10x], then every 6th row 1x (3x) [5x] and **AT THE SAME TIME,** after Row 84 (96) [108], **SHAPE RAGLAN:** Decrease 1 st. 22x (2 sts. 1x, 1 st. 23x) [2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 24x]. After Row 128 (144) [160], hang the remaining 6 sts. together and bind off.

SLEEVE: III Make 1, reverse 1.

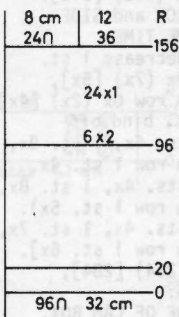
Cast on 36 (42) [48] sts. with color 1 and work 20 rows K1, P1 Ribbing.
Change to Stockinette stitch and ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 4th row 6x, every 6th row 10x. (every 6th row 16x). [every 6th row 10x, every 8th row 6x]. Knit to Row 104 (116) [128].
SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 17x (19x) [21x], then on the **BACK** side of sleeve, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 5x and on the **FRONT** SIDE, 1 st. 3x. After Row 148 (164) [180], work **SHORT ROWS:** ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, put into holding position 3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 5x. Bring all the needles back into working position then bind off loosely. Work the 2nd Sleeve with reverse shaping, casting on from right to left. Cam Box will be on the **LEFT** side at Row 0.



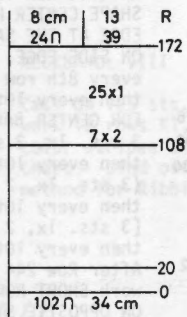

*Knit to Row 136 (148) [160] then bind off the remaining sts.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 104 (116) [128] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the raglan shaping.



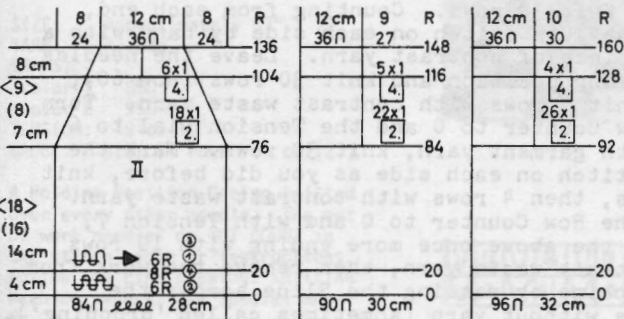

General Instructions

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THIS ISSUE

FULL FASHION DECREASING AND INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for decreasing or increasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch, then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the trip control lever so that only 1 row registers.

TO MAKE FRINGE

Cut yarn **DOUBLE** the length of fringe desired (wind around a cardboard or book). Using 2 or more strands of yarn (depending on weight of yarn) fold in half and with a crochet hook, draw folded loop through knitting from the wrong side. Pull strands through loop and tighten.

To make an additional row of knots on fringe, take half the strands from 1 group and half from the next group, then knot together approximately 1" to 2" below and continue across.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For **PULLOVERS, JACKETS** and **DRESSES:** Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a Cardigan or Jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in **KNITKING MAGAZINE**, we give you 3 Tension Numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows **WITHOUT** actually counting, by using our **KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE**.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast-on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn, then remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the **KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE** will do the figuring for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure **BETWEEN** the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn. Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy..? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

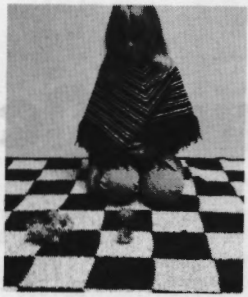
If you do not own a **KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE**, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.



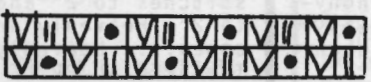
