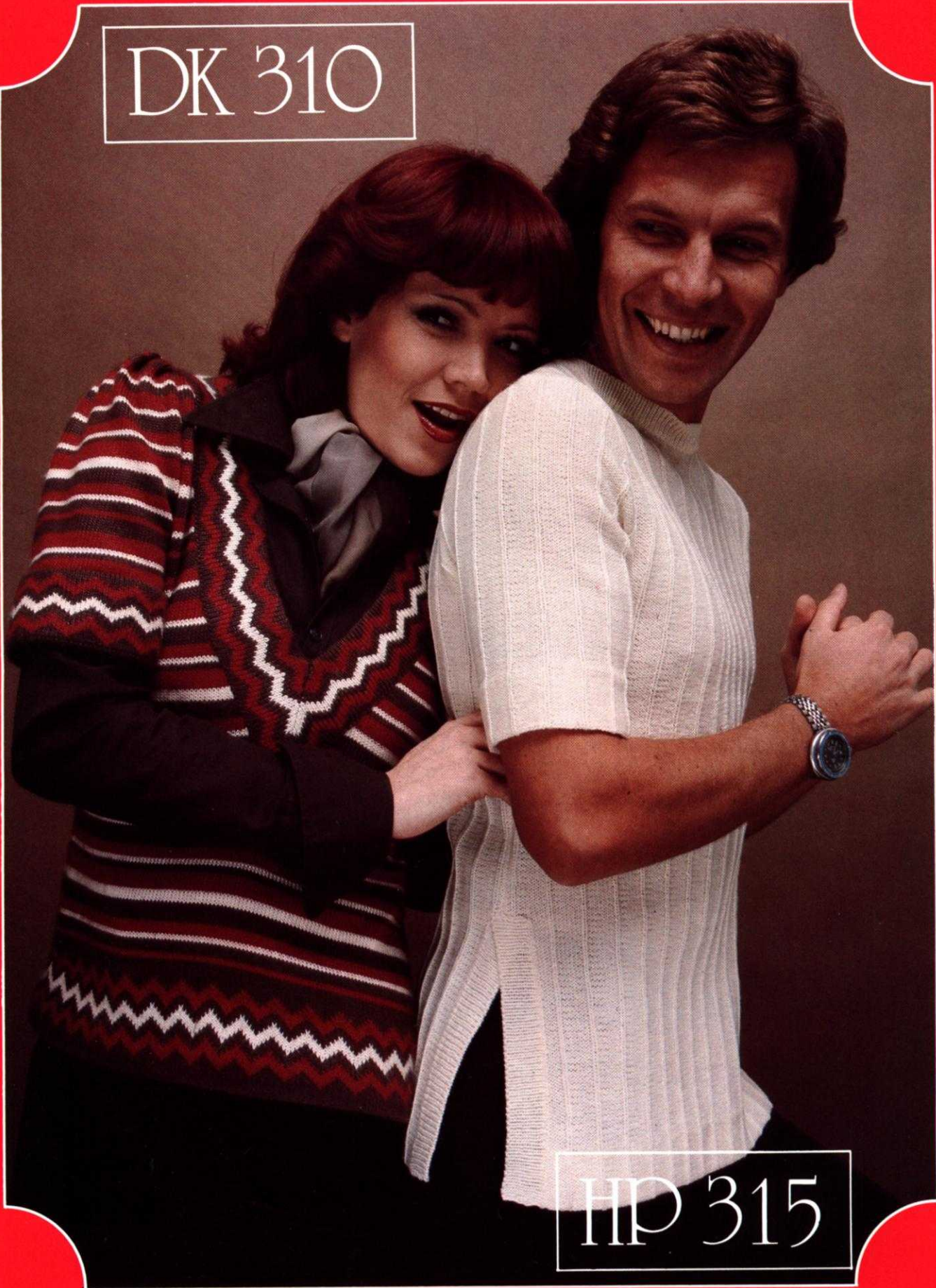









-  Increase
 Increase 2 sts. With a transfer tool, move the sts. over the left (or right) leaving 2 empty needles at the point of increase. At the increase point, move 1 st. to the left, (or right) so that there is an empty needles on each side of a stitch. On each side of the center stitch, pick up a stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

-  3 stitches on 1 needle. The 1st and 3rd stitch in a group of 3 has been hung on the 2nd or center needle.
 Short Row increase or decrease; for instance on a flared skirt knitted sideways.
 Pattern Stitch
 Pattern Stitch — worn on the Knit side.
 Pattern Stitch — worn on the Purl side.
 Norwegian Design using the Pattern Reader. Only 1 row must be registered on the Pattern Reader, so when knitting two or more colors in 1 row, knit the first color with the LEVER of Pattern Reader UP (working), then push the LEVER DOWN (non-working) for the additional colors.



General Instructions

HOW TO READ THE CHARTS AND INSTRUCTIONS

There are 3 sizes given for each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE. Above each Chart for the different sizes, you will see that the first and smaller sizes might be shown as 8/10, the second size as [12/14] and the third as [16/18]. Check the measurements at the bustline and hips on the Charts to be certain that you will knit the correct size, remembering these are ACTUAL measurements of the completed section and that there must be a bigger allowance at the bustline and hipline for a Jacket or a Coat than there would be for a fitted dress or a fitted blouse or pullover. The question in your mind should be "How do I want this garment to fit...?"

When you have chosen the size you need, you can follow the Charts as shown. You will notice that where the shapings are the same FOR ALL SIZES, only 1 set of shapings will be shown on the first Chart and if you are knitting the 2nd or 3rd size, you simply follow the shapings as given for the first size. If the shapings are different, this will be shown on the Charts and you should follow them as given.

On the Charts, increases and decreases will be shown as follows

5x1
6 The number in the box means number of ROWS between the shapings, while the 5x1 above the box means - 1 st. 5x... so you will increase or decrease 1 st. every 6th row 5x.

ARMHOLE SHAPINGS - NECK SHAPINGS - SHOULDER SHAPINGS - are made on every 2nd row UNLESS there is a number in a box along side or below the shapings. The rule is... where there is no box with a number, the shaping is made on every 2nd row.

THE PRINTED INSTRUCTIONS

You can follow the printed instructions or use them in combination with the Charts. Where there is any question in the printed instructions, you have the Charts to show you how the section will look.

The 3 sizes, with the different amounts of cast on stitches and the different shapings will look like this...

Cast on 124 (136) [148] sts. You will

Cast on 124 sts. for the first size.

Cast on 136 sts. for the 2nd size.

Cast on 148 sts. for the 3rd size.

The important thing to remember is that you MUST READ AHEAD so that you KNOW what to do for the size you are knitting. Sometimes where the number of stitches are the same but the number of times different, you will find shapings like this...

3 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 2 sts. 1x (2x) [3x], 1 st. 3x (4x) [5x]. As you see, you MUST read ahead in order to follow the instructions as given for YOUR SIZE. The rows will be different for the different sizes in some cases... Shoulder and Neck shapings usually are worked at the SAME TIME for the back section - so watch for the words AT THE SAME TIME.

HOLDING STITCHES ON THE LEFT SIDE WHILE SHAPING THE RIGHT SIDE

When knitting a section of garment in stockinette stitch, it is easy to hold the stitches on the left side while knitting the right half, but when knitting a Pattern Stitch such as a Norwegian Design, a Holding Position Design, Weaving, etc., you should use the following method. For the NECK SHAPING, we tell you to bind off the center sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first... so with a strand of contrast yarn, knit ALL of the left side stitches manually by hand, pulling each stitch back against the needle bed to the OUT OF WORK position. When the right side is completed, carefully pull the stitches held on contrast, forward into working position and as you do so, undo the contrast yarn, line up the needles (KNITKING machine owners, put the stitches under the sinkers) and complete the left half.

If you own a Japanese machine, you may find that when knitting the right half with the left side held in this way, the sinker plate will mark the left side while you are knitting the right half. To prevent this marking, you can tape a piece of paper over the knitting, underneath the sinkers, or if you own a Reversing Bar, you can hang this onto the Sinkers while you are knitting the right half. When hanging the Reversing Bar, be sure the eyes of the bar go BETWEEN the Sinker Posts on the upper part of the bar so that the tips of the bar only - show above the needle bed.

FULL FASHION DECREASING OR INCREASING

For Stockinette stitch, always use the Full Fashion method for increasing or decreasing.

TO DECREASE: Hang the 3rd stitch onto the 2nd stitch then move the stitches in to fill the empty needle.

TO INCREASE: Move the 2 end stitches 1 needle outward, then pick up the 3rd stitch from the row below and hang it onto the empty needle.

NORWEGIAN DESIGNS:

In the instructions, each row of the Norwegian Design is counted as 1 row but several movements of the Cam Box (or Slide) are needed to complete 1 row.

NORWEGIAN DESIGN WHEN USING THE PATTERN READER

When you use the Pattern Reader and knit a Norwegian Design using several colors, it is necessary to move the Trip Control Lever so that only 1 row registers.

FINISHING: Block all sections. For PULLOVERS, JACKETS, and DRESSES: Join front to back at sides and shoulders. Sew sleeves together and set in. Hem lower edge and sleeve edges if needed. For a double neckband or armhole band, sew 1 edge to the inside and 1 to the outside of neck or armhole. For a single ribbed band, sew 1 edge to the outside of neck or armhole edge. For a cardigan or jacket with buttonholes, finish buttonholes and sew on buttons.

PANTS: Join front to back at sides. Sew inside leg seams, then join center front and back. Make hem at waistline and insert elastic. Hem lower edge of pants legs.

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

Before you begin to knit any garment, you will need to knit a sample piece using the yarn you have chosen for your garment, so that you can check the stitch and row gauge which must measure the correct number of stitches and rows in 5 cm (2 inches).

For each Pattern in KNITKING MAGAZINE, we give you 3 tension numbers to work from and if you use the specified yarn for the garment, you should be able to get the correct stitch and row gauge using one of these numbers. Here is a very easy way to make your sample swatch and count the stitches and rows without actually counting, by using our KNITKING Converta Tape.

Supposing the Tension Numbers for the Stitch and Row Gauge are given as 5 to 7. Set the Tension Dial to the first number which is 5. With contrast waste yarn, and using the quick cast on method, cast on 60 stitches and knit 10 rows. Change to garment yarn and turn the Row Counter to 0. Knit 30 rows. Counting from each end, knit the 10th stitch on each side by hand with a small piece of contrast yarn. Leave the needles in working position and knit 30 rows (Row 60), then knit 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and the Tension Dial to 6 and with garment yarn, knit 30 rows. Mark the 10th stitch on each side as you did before, knit 30 rows, then 4 rows with contrast waste yarn. Turn the Row Counter to 0 and with Tension 7, repeat the above once more, ending with 10 rows of contrast waste yarn. Remove the work from the machine by passing the Slide across the needles without yarn (sometimes called 'dropping').

Pull and stretch the sample piece both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner, then lengthwise again. Do not count the stitches and rows immediately, but allow the sample to rest for several hours or even over night. This will allow the stitches and rows to return to their basic form.

When your sample has rested and you are ready to count the stitches and rows, the KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE will do the counting for you without any counting on your part. Use the Tape as follows:

To measure the stitches, pull out the Tape to measure BETWEEN the 40 stitches in the center that you marked by hand knitting with contrast waste yarn - Push the red marker on the Tape so that it points to 40 stitches on the Tape. Your stitch gauge to 5 cm (2 inches) will shown in the red window on the tape. To find the number of rows in 5 cm (2 inches), place the tape to measure over 60 rows, push the red marker to 60 on the tape and your row gauge for 5 cm (2 inches) will show in the red window... Easy...? If you do not get the correct stitch and row gauge in the first part of your sample, then try the other two.

If you do not own a KNITKING CONVERTA TAPE, you must mark a 5 cm (2 inch) square in the center of the knitting, then count the number of stitches and rows within the square.

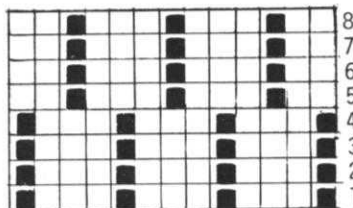

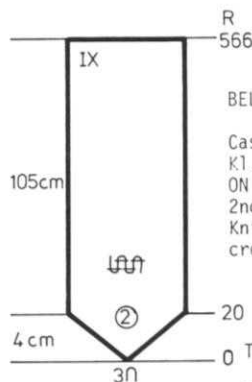

Cast on 3 sts. with color 2 and work K1, P1 Ribbing.
 ON EACH SIDE, increase 2 sts. every 2nd row 10x.
 Knit to Row 566, then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

TUNIC BACK: II

Cast on 114 (126) [138] sts. with color 1 and work the Norwegian Design. Knit to Row 12, then hang the hem.
 ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 30th row 6x, every 28th row 3x.
 (every 22nd row 8x, every 20th row 4x).
 [every 18th row 6x, every 16th row 9x].
 Knit to Row 276.

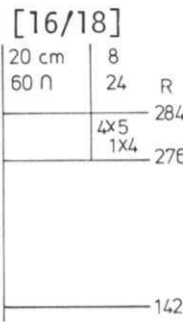
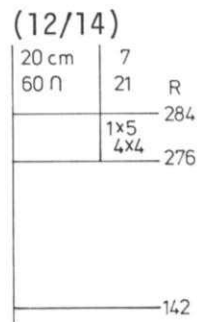
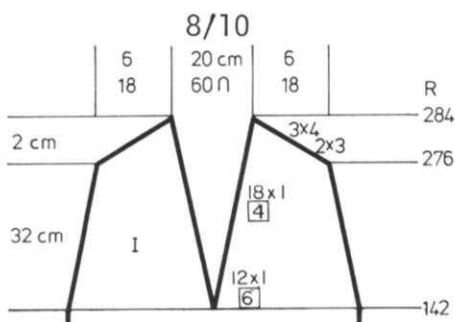
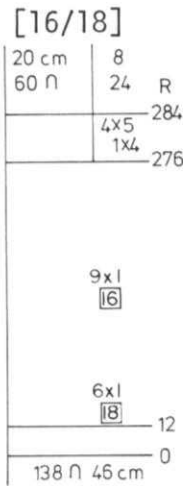
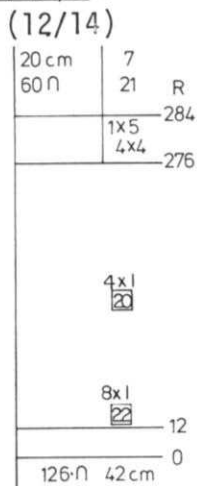
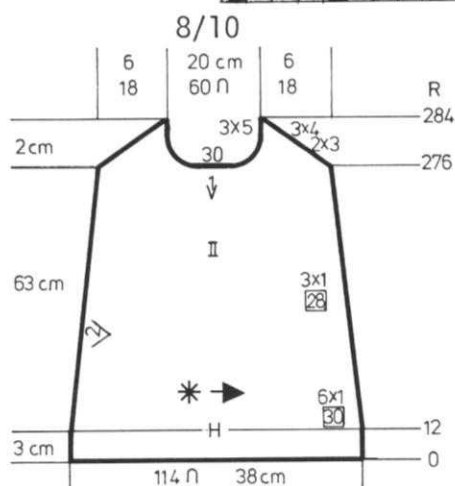
Bind off the center 30 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

*SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.

FOR SHOULDER, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 3x. (4 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 1x). [4 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 4x].

FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 3x.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 276 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



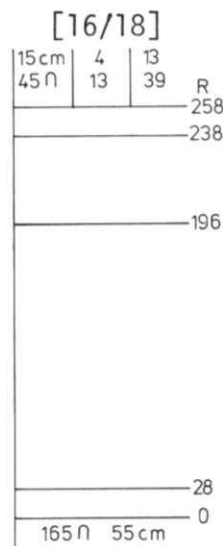
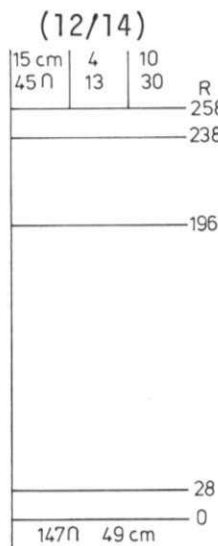
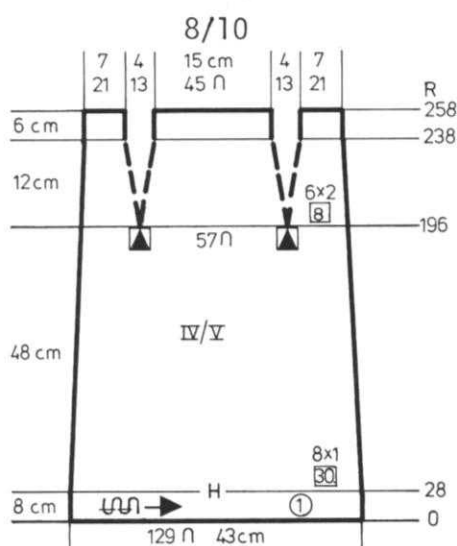
FRONT: I

Work the front the same as the back to Row 142.

Divide in the center, put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

*Continue the decreases on side edge the same as the back and ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 1 st. every 6th row 12x, every 4th row 18x, and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 276.

Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 142 and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.



SKIRT FRONT & BACK: IV/V

Cast on 129 (147) [165] sts. with color 1 and work Stockinette stitch.

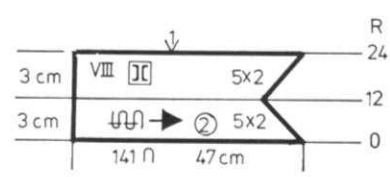
Knit to Row 28, then hang the hem. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 30th row 8x.

After Row 196, ON EACH SIDE, decrease 2 sts. FOR EACH DART.

The first DART decrease is made ON EACH SIDE of the center 57 sts. with the following dart decreases directly above.

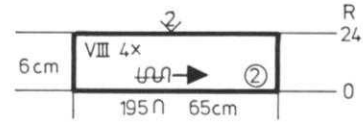
Decrease 2 sts. for EACH DART every 8th row 5x more.

Knit to Row 258, then bind off. Make the 2nd section the same.



NECKBAND: VIII Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 141 sts. with color 2 and work Stockinette stitch.
ON THE RIGHT (left for 2nd section) decrease 2 sts. every 2nd row 5x, then increase 2 sts. every 2nd row 5x. After Row 24, bind off.

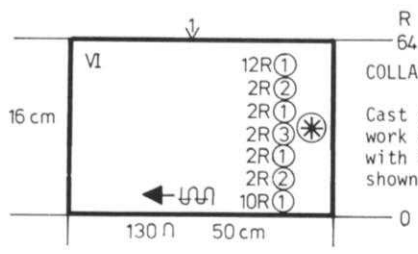


SIDE BANDS: VIII Make 4.
Cast on 195 sts. with color 2 and work 24 rows Stockinette stitch then bind off.

(4 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 1x)
[5 sts. 5x].
FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 3x.
Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 220 (224) [228] and complete the left side. Follow the instructions from *.

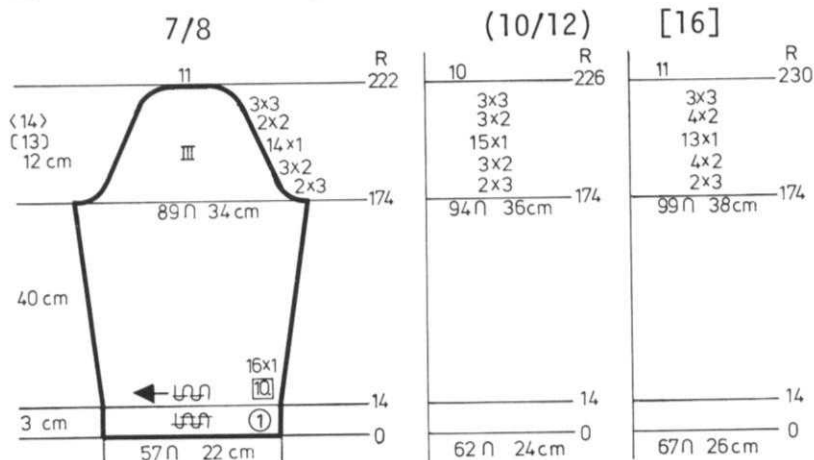

Work the front the same as the back to Row 152, then knit to Row 164.
SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back then knit to Row 204 (208) [212].
Bind off the center 13 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.
*ON NECK SIDE for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x, and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 232 (236) [240].
Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 204 (208) [212] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *

SLEEVE: III

Cast on 57 (62) [67] sts. with color 1 and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch and ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 16x. Knit to Row 174. SHAPE CAP: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 14x, 2 sts. 2x, 3 sts. 3x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 15x, 2 sts. 3x, 3 sts. 3x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 13x, 2 sts. 4x, 3 sts. 3x]. After Row 222 (226) [230], bind off the remaining 11 (10) [11] sts.

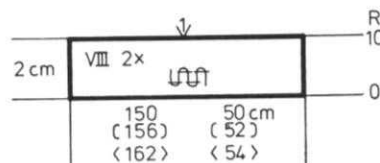

WOMAN'S VEST

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16/18]
 YARN: Crocus Crepe
 GRAMS: 250 300 350
 TENSION: 6 to 8
 GAUGE: 15 sts. 20 rows = 5 cm (2")

A Holding Position Design that follows the Line Drawing. KNITTING machine owners use Wheel No. 2 and push in the LEFT Retractor Button and leave it there. The purl side is the right side. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



ARMBANDS: VIII Make 2.

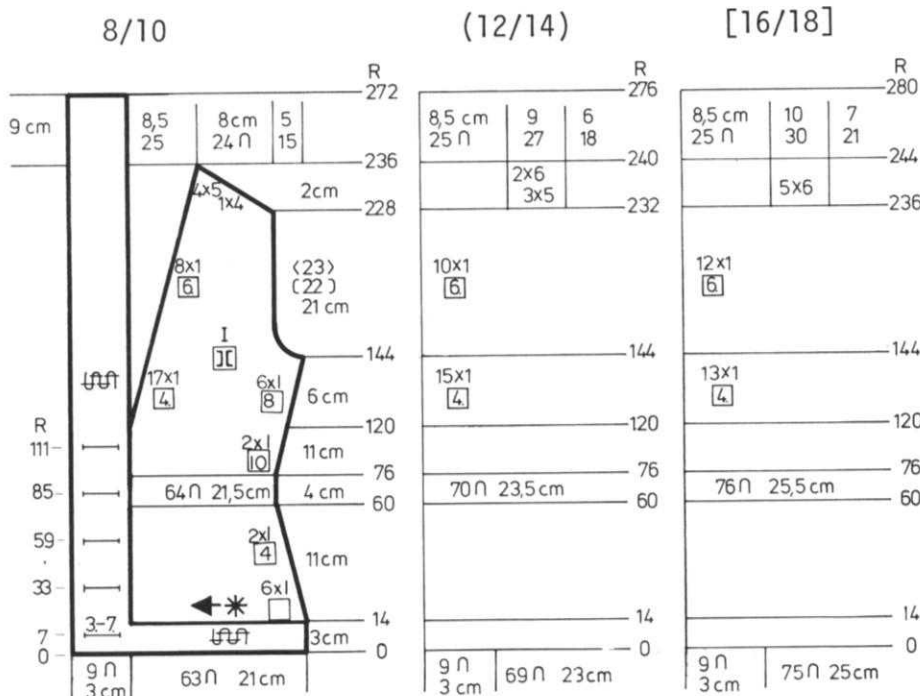
Cast on 150 (156) [162] sts. and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing, then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.



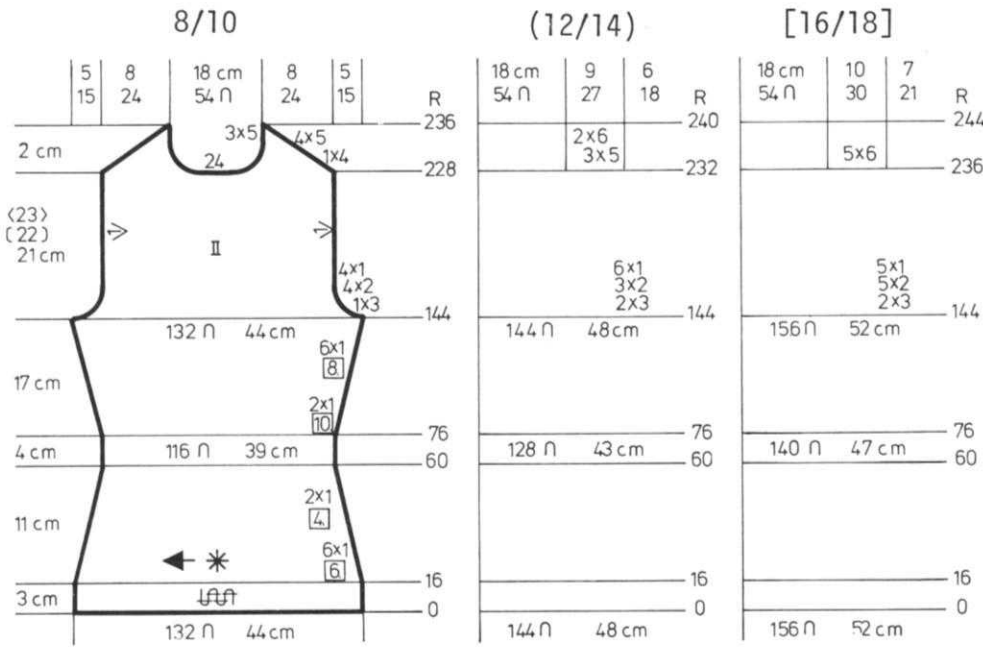
FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

DO NOT MAKE BUTTONHOLES IN THIS SECTION.

Cast on 72 (78) [84] sts. and work 14 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Leave 9 sts. on the LEFT (right for 2nd section) in K1, P1 Ribbing and transfer the remaining rib stitches to the main machine. Continue in Holding Position Design with the 9 sts. in K1, P1 Ribbing. ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 6x, every 4th row 2x. Knit to Row 76. ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 2x, every 8th row 6x AND AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 120, remove the 9 rib sts. onto contrast waste yarn. Remove the Ribber from the machine and continue in Pattern. ON NECK SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 4th row 17x (15x) [13x], every 6th row 8x (10x) [12x] and SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back after Row 144 and SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 228 (232) [236]. Return the stitches held on waste yarn to the main machine and Ribber. Turn the Row Counter back to 120 and work K1, P1 Ribbing to Row 272 (276) [280]. Bind off the crochet method for Ribbing. Make the 2nd section with reverse shaping and work BUTTONHOLES over needles 3 to 7 counting from the RIGHT edge, after the rows shown on the Chart.



BACK: II



Cast on 132 [144] [156] sts. and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to the Holding Position Design. ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 6th row 6x, every 4th row 2x. Knit to Row 76. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 10th row 2x, every 8th row 6x. Knit to Row 144. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 4x, 1 st. 4x. (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 6x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 5x, 1 st. 5x]. Knit to Row 228 (232) [236]. Bind off *the center 24 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER, bind off 4 sts. 1x, 5 sts. 4x. (5 sts. 3x, 6 sts. 2x). [6 sts. 5x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes bind off 5 sts. 3x. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 228 (232) [236] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

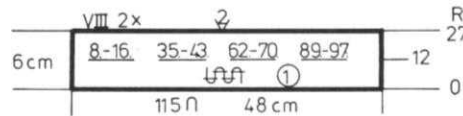

SIZES: 8 (10/12) [14/16]
 YARN: Allegro
 GRAMS: color 1 300 350 400
 color 2 50 100 100
 TENSION: 8 to 10
 GAUGE: 12 sts. 16 rows = 5 cm (2")

Stockinette stitch with REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart. Worn on the purl side. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions.



FRONT BANDS: VIII Make 2 but omit buttonholes in 2nd section.

Cast on 115 sts. and work K1, P1 Ribbing. After Row 12, make BUTTONHOLES over needles 8 to 16, 35 to 43, 62 to 70, 89 to 97 counting from the LEFT edge. After Row 27, bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

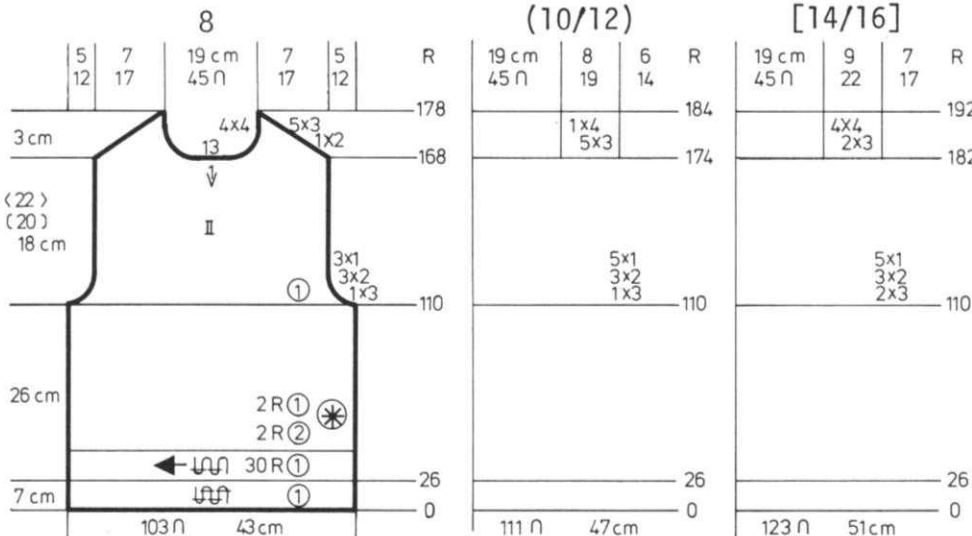
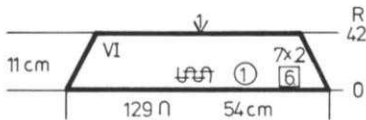


BACK: II

Cast on 103 (111) [123] sts. with color 1 and work 26 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. Knit to Row 56 then work the REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart to Row 110. Continue with color 1. SHAPE ARMHOLE: ON EACH SIDE, bind off 3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 3x. (3 sts. 1x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x). [3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x]. Knit to Row 168 (174) [182]. Bind off the center 13 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first. *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME. FOR SHOULDER bind off 2 sts. 1x, 3 sts. 5x. (3 sts. 5x, 4 sts. 1x). [3 sts. 2x, 4 sts. 4x]. FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 4 sts. 4x. Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 168 (174) [182] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

COLLAR: VI

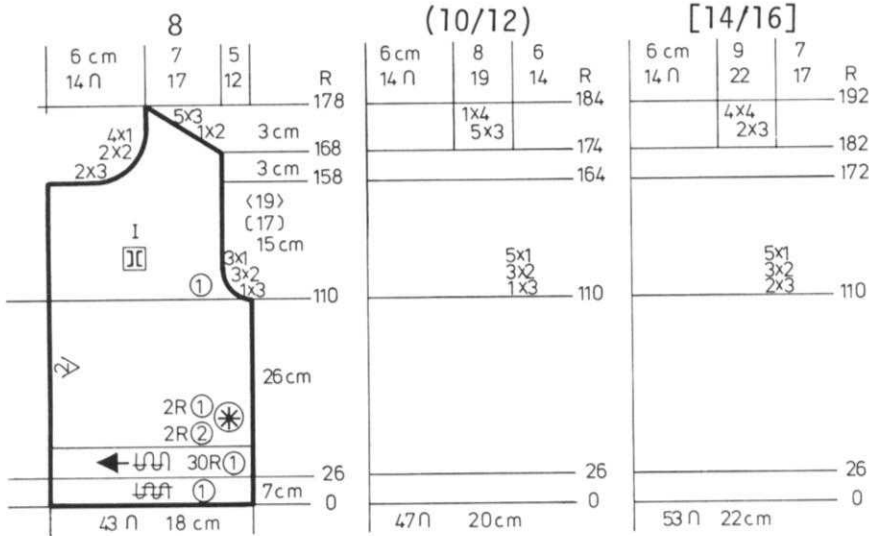
Cast on 129 sts. with color 1 and work K1, P1 Ribbing. ON EACH SIDE, on every 6th row, decrease 2 sts. 7x. After Row 42, bind off the remaining sts. the crochet method for Ribbing.

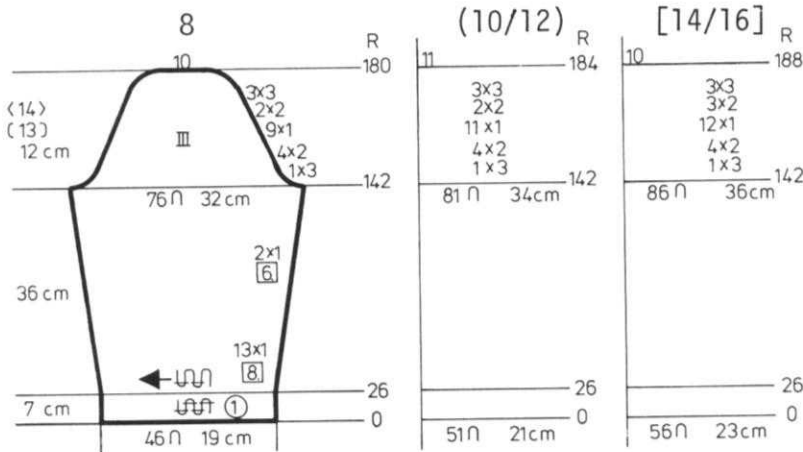

FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 43 (47) [53] sts. with color 1 and work 26 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch and knit 30 rows color 1 then work the REPEATED color stripes as shown on the Chart to Row 110. Continue with color 1. SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back then knit to Row 157 (163) [171]. ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 2x, 1 st. 4x and AT THE SAME TIME, SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back after Row 168 (174) [182].



SLEEVE: III

Cast on 46 (51) [56] sts. with color 1 and work 26 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 13x, every 6th row 2x. Knit to Row 142.  (3 sts. 2x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x).
 [3 sts. 3x, 2 sts. 3x, 1 st. 5x].
 Knit to Row 250 (254) [258].
 Bind off the center 15 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.
 *SHAPE SHOULDER AND NECK AT THE SAME TIME.
 FOR SHOULDER, bind off
 3 sts. 3x, 4 sts. 4x.
 (4 sts. 7x).
 [4 sts. 4x, 5 sts. 3x].
 FOR NECK, on all sizes, bind off 5 sts. 3x.
 Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 250 (254) [258] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from *.

FRONT: I Make 1, reverse 1.

Cast on 53 (59) [65] sts. and work Stockinette stitch.
 Knit to Row 12.
 ON SIDE EDGE, decrease 1 st. every 38th row 3x.
 Knit to Row 102.
 ON SIDE EDGE, increase 1 st. every 26th row 3x.
 Knit to Row 156.
 SHAPE FRONT: Decrease 1 st. every 8th row 7x, every 10th row 7x and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 182, SHAPE ARMHOLE same as the back and after Row 250 (254) [258], SHAPE SHOULDER same as the back.



COLLAR: VI

Cast on 123 sts. and work 58 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

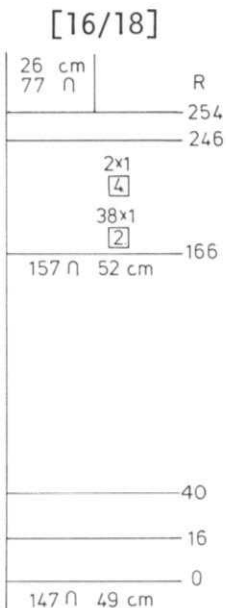
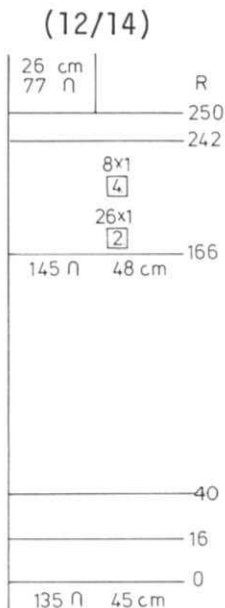
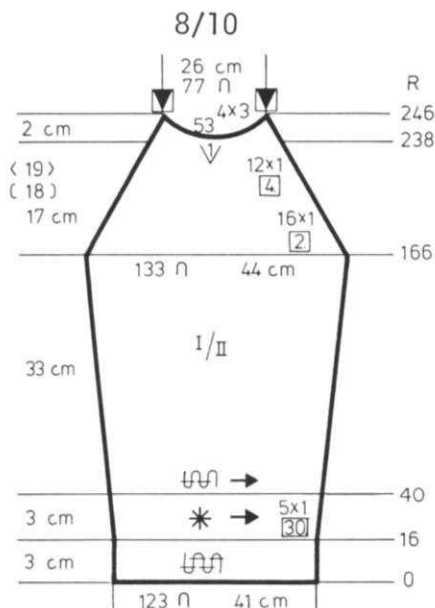


WOMAN'S PULLOVER

SIZES: 8/10 (12/14) [16/18]
 YARN: Crocus
 GRAMS: 350 400 450
 TENSION: 6 to 8
 GAUGE: 15 sts. 21 rows = 5 cm (2")

An Eyelet Design that follows the Line Drawing. The knit side is the right side. Bands are K1, P1 Ribbing.

FINISHING: See General Instructions



BACK & FRONT: I/II

Cast on 123 (135) [147] sts. and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to the Eyelet Design and ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 30th row 5x and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 40, change to Stockinette stitch.

Knit to Row 166. SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, decrease 1 st. every 2nd row 16x (26x) [38x], every 4th row 12x (8x) [2x] and after Row 238 (242) [246], bind off the center 53 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

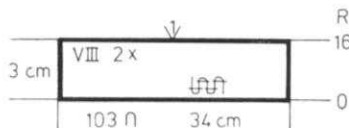
*ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 4x.

After Row 246 (250) [254], hang the remaining sts. together and bind off.

Move the Cam Box to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 238 (242) [246] and complete the left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the raglan shaping.

NECKBAND: VIII Make 2.

Cast on 103 sts. and work 16 rows K1, P1 Ribbing then bind off the crochet method for Ribbing.

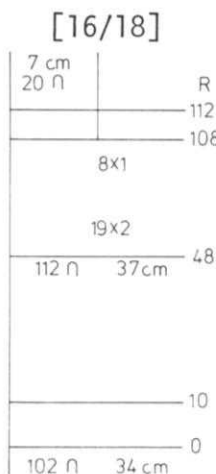
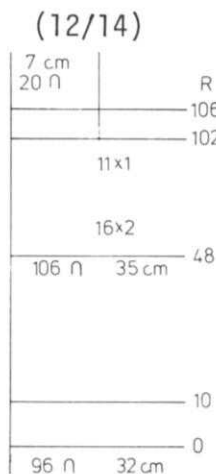
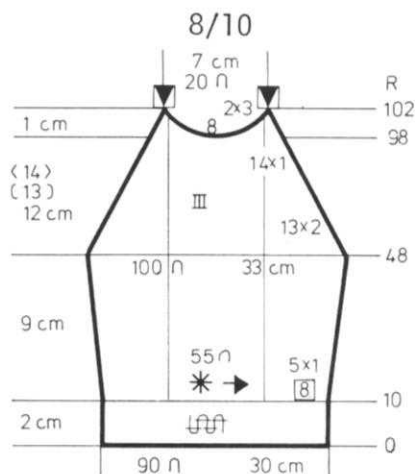


SLEEVES: III

Cast on 90 (96) [102] sts. and work 10 rows K1, P1 Ribbing. Change to Stockinette stitch with EYELET DESIGN over the CENTER 55 sts. ON EACH SIDE, increase 1 st. every 8th row 5x.

Knit to Row 48. SHAPE RAGLAN: ON EACH SIDE, on every 2nd row, decrease 2 sts. 13x (16x) [19x], 1 st. 14x (11x) [8x] and AT THE SAME TIME, after Row 98 (102) [108], bind off the center 8 sts., put the needles on the left into holding position and complete the right half first.

*ON NECK SIDE, for all sizes, bind off 3 sts. 2x. After Row 102 (106) [112], hang the remaining sts. together and bind off. Bring the needles on the left into working position, knit 1 row in Pattern to the left side, turn the Row Counter back to 98 (102) [108] and complete left half. Follow the instructions from * and don't forget to complete the raglan shaping.





KnitKING News

PRACTICAL KNITTING HINTS

DECREASING 2 STS. ON SIDE EDGE

When a Pattern calls for you to decrease 2 sts. ON EACH SIDE, on every 2nd row, such as on the Sleeve of DK 326 in this issue, you can if you like, decrease 1 st. each side on EVERY ROW and an easy way to do this (especially when working a design) is to transfer the 2nd stitch to the first stitch, then move the doubled stitch to the 2nd needle and push the empty needle to the out of work position.

This method for decreasing 1 st. on the edge can be used for shaping sleeves in Stockinette stitch as well, especially if you do not want the full fashion method which does show the shaping.

SHORT ROWS

If you do not like wrapping the yarn when knitting Short Rows, try another method with the yarn you will use for garment to see if you like it.

Supposing you are short rowing a Bust Dart... and the pattern tells you to put into holding position 8 sts. 4x on every 2nd row. ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, *put into holding position, 7 stitches., knit across, then bring the 8th stitch into holding position, knit across. REPEAT from * 3x more. Now bring all the needles into working position and knit the row. This is the method to use for the Bust Dart on the front of a cardigan or jacket. If you are working on a Pullover, you should work BOTH sides in the same way for the front section Bust Darts.

For working Short Rows on a sideways knitted Skirt, it might be necessary for you to bring the needles back into working position in order to complete a panel, so this is the method to try on a sample swatch.

Cast on 60 sts., knit 4 rows.
ON OPPOSITE SIDE OF CAM BOX, on every 2nd row, put into holding position, 10 sts. 5x in this manner. *Put 9 sts. into holding position, knit across, then bring the 10th st. into holding position, knit across. REPEAT from * 4x more. You have 10 sts. left in working position. Now bring the holding needles back into working position as follows: The first time, push back 10 sts., knit across, and bring the inside 10th st. back into holding position, knit across. Now bring back 11 sts., knit across and bring 11th stitch back into holding position... Continue to bring 11 sts. back into work, knit the row and bring the 11th back into holding until all the stitches are in work. The last time when you bring the 11 sts. back into work, DO NOT bring the 11th st. into holding. Knit 6 rows and REPEAT from the beginning. When using this method for a boucle yarn which has a nub, you will not be able to see the wrapped needle stitches on either side of the knitting... However, if you are using a smooth yarn, the stitches will show on the purl side but the knit side is very nice.. try it....
