Each change in pattern is sectioned off with a Pin Tuck trim. The cross-over Collar, waist and sleeve bands are ribbed. Knit it with Softon on a Standard Punch Card or Electronic machine.

Counterpart

A man's version of Pullover 896 is knitted vertically for a dramatic change. We used the same Fairisle Designs and outlined each section with the same Pin Tuck. The cross-over Collar, sleeve and waistband are 1 x 1 Ribbing. Knit it on a Standard Punch Card or Electronic machine using Softon.

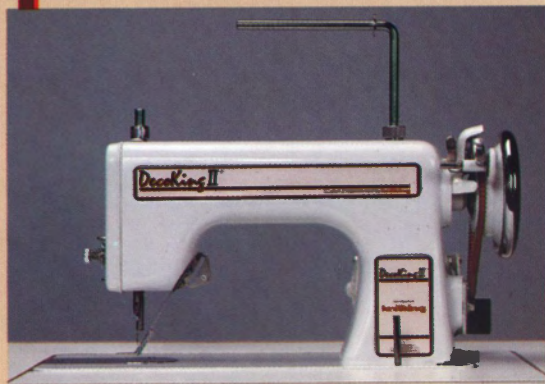

The DecoKing II allows the fabric to be moved by hand in any direction. A lock stitch prevents the yarn or trim from coming off the fabric, giving you 100% coverage on top. This differs from other embroidery machines which puncture yarn through to the back of the fabric.

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GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

THE SAMPLE SWATCH

It is imperative that you knit a sample swatch for every garment. Although you may be using the identical yarn and machine model as the pattern suggests, many variables such as dye lot difference, speed of knitting and just machine to machine differences can all cause a variance in the gauge achieved. Knitmagazine publishes the tension and gauge for each garment shown. We strongly urge you to knit a swatch representing three tensions - the recommended tension, and .1 or .2 higher and lower. These different tensions can be knitted in one piece with waste yarn separating the sections. This will eliminate unnecessary rethreading while allowing you to obtain the gauge published in the magazine.

To make a sample swatch on standard gauge machines cast on 60 stitches with waste yarn. Knit approximately 6 rows. *Mark the tension number for your swatch by making holes. For example 4 eyelet holes for Tension 4, 6 eyelet holes for Tension 6. Knit 6 more rows.

Change to garment yarn and reset row counter to 0. Knit 30 rows (in Pattern stitch). With contrast yarn, mark the 10th stitch FROM EACH SIDE by hand. Knit 30 Rows. Change to waste yarn and knit 6 rows. Change tension up or down for second section and repeat from *. Make third section with another tension. Remove on 12 Rows of waste yarn. Remove the sts. from the machine

by pushing the Carriage across without yarn.

Pull and stretch the swatch both lengthwise and diagonally from corner to corner. Gently block the swatch. Treat the swatch as you would the finished garment before measuring the gauge. For example, if you plan to wash this garment and dry it in the dryer, you should do so, measuring before and after to see the difference.

Measure between the stitches marked and the beginning and ending rows for the inches/cms. knitted. Divide the total number of stitches/rows by the inches measured to calculate sts. and rows per inch.

For Bulky knitters, make swatch with 30 Sts. and 30 Rows. If so desired, or for large pattern repeats, we suggest a wider and longer swatch to provide more accurate gauges.

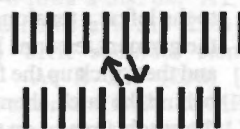

BUTTONHOLES

The following methods of buttonholes are the general manner in which small and large buttonholes are created.

Small Buttonholes in Ribbing
Make small eyelet style buttonholes by following chart below.

Buttonhole Transfer
Center St. of Each Bed to Next St. of Other Bed



Large Buttonholes in FNR
Vertical buttonholes are made by knitting each side separately (partial or short-row knitting). Knit the right side first, end with yarn on left. Without breaking yarn, knit left side. The strand of yarn inside the buttonhole can be picked up every other row when knitting the left side, but this is not necessary for a small buttonhole.

SHORT ROWS

Method One

With carriage on opposite side start placing appropriate number of ndls in HP. Knit across and wrap the inside needle. Again, place appropriate number of ndls in HP on opposite side from carriage, knit across and repeat wrapping. The wrapping will eliminate any holes in the knitting.

Method Two - Automatic Wrap

Example follows for shoulder short rows. This method can be used for other Short Rowing as well. For example if pattern says to Short Row at shoulder every other row 7 sts, 1 x and 6 sts. 1 x . . . With carriage on opposite side put 6 sts in HP, knit 1 row across and put one additional needle in HP. Opposite carriage place 6 ndls in HP. Knit 1 row across and bring one extra needle to HP. Repeat until shortrowing is completed.

HEMS

Two methods of knitting hems are described below. Variations on these instructions will allow you to knit plain hems, picot edge hems and more.

Method One

With waste yarn cast on the required number of stitches and knit about 10-12 rows ending with the carriage on the left. Knit 1 Row to the right with Ravel Cord. Change to garment yarn and knit 1 Row to the left at garment body tension. (i.e. Skirt at Tension 4, 1st row at T 4). Turn tension down approximately 2 full tension numbers lower (tighter) and knit to mid point. (i.e. Row 14 of a 28-row hem). Change tension to 1 full tension lower than garment body and knit remainder of hem rows. Pick up the stitches from the first row of garment yarn - shown between the stitches of Ravel Cord. Hem is now completed. Proceed with pattern as per chart and instruc-

tions. Remove waste yarn and Ravel Cord when you have completed section.

Method Two

Bring required number of needles to "B" (working) position. Attach cast-on comb. Beginning with the 2nd needle on the LEFT, bring every other needle to "D" or "E" position. Push in both Part buttons. Knit 1 Row to the left. Release the part buttons and drop the cast-on comb. (DO NOT REMOVE cast on comb from work). Knit required number of rows for hem. Attach weights to the back of work close to the cast-on comb (about 1/4" above the comb). Beginning with the 1st needle on the LEFT, bring every other needle to "D" position. Carefully LIFT the cast-on comb and hang loops onto the needles in "D" position. Turn the comb back away from you and make sure the needles are through the loops. Pull the needles out to "E" position and remove the cast-on comb.

AT THE SAME TIME - Two functions are to be performed at the same time, such as shaping the neck and shoulder. Be sure to read both instructions before proceeding.

BO - Bind Off. To take off more than 1 St. at a time. When two or more stitches are to be bound off (or cast on) the carriage and yarn must be on the same side as the bind off. If the instruction is, "At R 100 BO 6 Sts on each side.", on the carriage side BO six stitches, knit one row and then bind off six stitches on the other side. See DECR and FF DECR.

BOLT - Slip Stitch Bind Off with a Latch Tool. Knit one row to the left at a tension at least five numbers higher (looser) than the garment tension. Bring all needles to holding position ("E") and then, pick up the first stitch on a latch tool allowing it to slip behind the latch, then pick up the next stitch and pull it through the stitch already on the latch hook, thus creating a slip stitch. If you cannot set the tension at least five full tension numbers higher, knit a row loosely manually.

CO - Cast on stitches for knitting. (CHECK INSTRUCTION MANUALS TO MAKE SURE DIFFERENT METHODS ARE SHOWN) In our instructions, CO is used either for a finished edge at the beginning of the garment, or to add edge stitch(es). If two or more stitches are to be cast on the carriage and yarn must be on the same side as the cast on. If the instruction is, "At R 100 CO 6 Sts on each side.", on the carriage side cast on six stitches, knit one row and then cast on six stitches on the other side.

COR - Carriage on Right

COL - Carriage on Left

DEC R - Use the transfer tool to move the edge stitch(es) inward to the next needle. Usually used to transfer one edge stitch to the next needle, but may be used to transfer the two edge stitches to the next two needles.

EON - Every other needle

EOR - Every other row

EOS - Every other stitch

FF DECR - Used to make an even edge for seaming and decorative seams for raglans. If one stitch is to be decreased, use a two-prong transfer tool to move the two edge stitches inward one needle. If two stitches are to be decreased, use a three-prong transfer tool to move the three edge stitches in two needles. If three stitches are to be decreased, use two two-prong transfer tools and move the edge stitches in four needles. See DECR, BO and SHAPING.

FF INCR - To increase one stitch move the two edge stitches outward one needle, then fill the empty needle by picking up a bar from the row below and hanging it on the empty needle.

FNR - Full Needle Rib

G.C. - Garter Carriage

HP - Holding position or "E" position.

INCR - Increase. Usually used for "full-fashion" shaping, see FF Incr., or in conjunction with short row shaping. A simple incr can be made by pulling additional needle on side of carriage out to "E" position and knit across.

MB - Main Bed

MC - Main Color

Ndls - Needles

NWP - Non-working position or position "A"

R(s) - Row(s)

RB - Ribber Bed

RC - Row Counter.

RC 0 - Set RC to zero.

SET PATTERN - Follow the step-by-step instructions in your manual for setting the pattern and carriage controls for the pattern to be knit, e.g., Fairisle, tuck, single motif, etc.

SHAPING: The method used for shaping is a matter of personal preference. In our definitions we have described the methods commonly in use at Knitking. Which method is chosen for a particular pattern depends upon the garment, the yarn and the personal preference of the designer.

SHR - Short Row or Partial Knitting. Used for shaping shoulders, necklines, darts, gores, etc. Set carriage on H(old). **Every other row SHRs:** On the opposite side of the carriage, place the specified number of stitches in holding position, knit across, wrap the inner needle or use an "automatic wrap". After all specified stitches have been placed in HP change the carriage setting to N (knit) to return the needles to WP. **Every row SHRs:** On the side being shaped, place one stitch in HP every row. It is recommended you refer to your manual or an instruction book for detailed instructions about how to short row.

St(s) - Stitch(es)

St. St. - Stockinette stitch.

T - Tension.

WP - Working Position or "B" position.

WY - Waste yarn.

YM - Yarn marker. To place a yarn marker, use a short piece of contrasting yarn and loop it over the needle specified or the end needle of the row specified.

SEAMING GARMENTS

Any number of popular methods are suggested. We encourage you to experiment with any and all. If a garment in Knitking Magazine requires special seaming information it will be provided in the individual pattern instruction. Otherwise, methods include: linking on the knitting machine, Knitking's Lectrolink, the electric linker, crochet slip stitch, tapestry needles with back stitch sewing by hand. Bar to bar weaving for seamless appearance and seaming on a sewing machine.

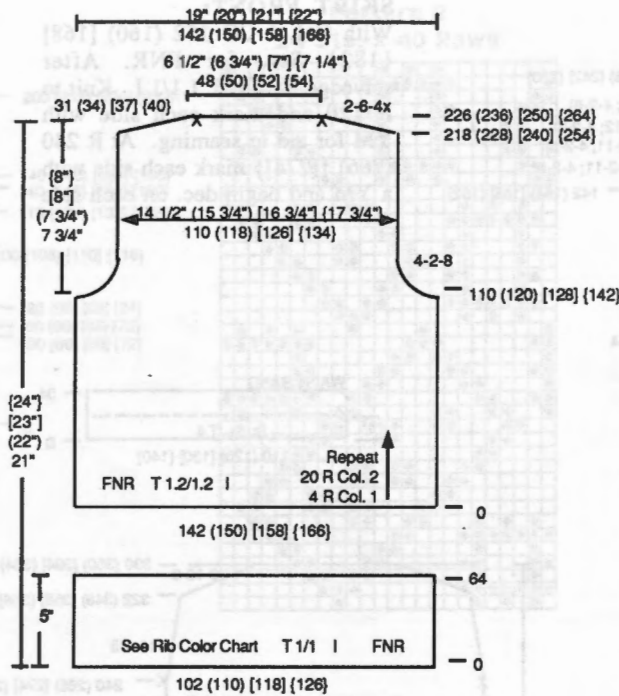

BACK:

With Col. 1 CO 142 (150) [158] [166] Sts. FNR. After selvedge, change to T 1.2/1.2 I. Knit in stripe pattern:

Col. 1 - 4 R
Col. 2 - 20 R

Continue stripe pattern. At R 110 (120) [128] [142] begin armhole shaping. On each side decr. every 4 Rs. 2 Sts. 8x for all sizes. Knit to R 218 (228) [240] [254]. Begin SHR shoulder shaping on each side EOR 6 Sts. 4x. Transfer RB Sts. to MB at R 226 (236) [250] [264], knit last row at T 10 and mark center 48 (50) [52] [54] Sts. with YM for collar placement and neck opening. BOLT.

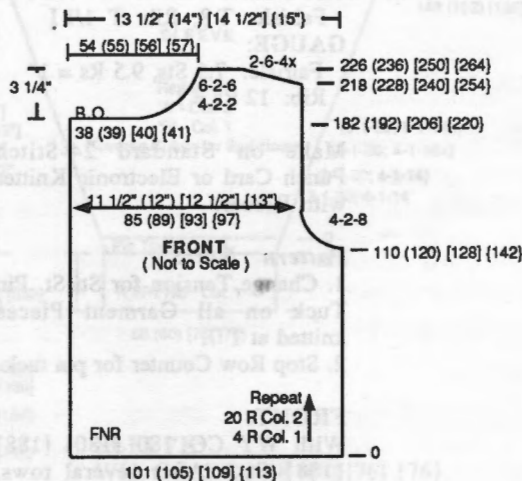

With Col. 1 and 3 CO 102 (110) [118] [126] Sts. for FNR. After selvedge, RC 0. T 1/1 I. Knit to R 64 following Rib Color Chart. Transfer RB Sts. to MB. With purl side facing, rehang lower edge of back on these ndls, decr. evenly across. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

FRONT:

Make 1, Reverse 1.
With Col. 1 CO 101 (105) [109] [113] Sts. FNR. After selvedge, change to T 1.2/1.2 I. Knit in stripe pattern:

Col. 1 - 4 R
Col. 2 - 20 R

Continue stripe pattern. At R 110 (120) [128] [142] begin armhole shaping. On right side decr. every 4 Rs. 2 Sts. 8x for all sizes. Knit to R 182 (192) [206] [220] and begin neckline shaping. On neckline BO 38 (39) [40] [41] Sts. Continue shaping neckline decr. every 4 rows 2 St. 2x and every 6 rows 2 Sts. 6x. AT THE SAME TIME at R 218 (228) [240] [254] SHR shoulder same as back. At R 226 (236) [250] [264] transfer RB Sts. to MB and knit last row at T 10 and BOLT.

RIBBED BANDS:

Make 1 with buttonholes, 1 without.

CO 72 (80) [88] [96] Sts. for FNR. After selvedge RC 0. T 1/1 I. Following Rib Color Chart knit to R 64, making buttonholes (see chart) with WY over 2 Sts. at R 12 and R 52. Transfer RB Sts. to MB. With purl side facing, rehang lower edge of front on these ndls, decr. evenly across. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

SLEEVE:

Make 2 the same.
With Col. 1 CO 98 (100) [102] [104] Sts. for FNR. After selvedge, change to T 1.2/1.2 I. Knit in stripe pattern:

Col. 1 - 4 R
Col. 2 - 20 R

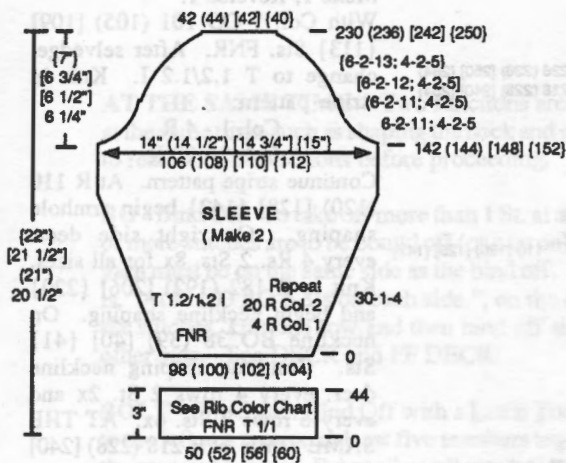
Continue stripe pattern while shaping sleeve. On each side incr. every 30 Rs. 1 St. 4x. At R 142 (144) [148] [152] shape sleeve cap. On each side decr. every 6 Rs. 2 St. 11x and every 4 Rs. 2 St. 5x (every 6 Rs. 2 St. 11x and every 4 Rs. 2 St. 5x) [every 6 Rs. 2 St. 12x and every 4 Rs. 2 St. 5x] [every 6 Rs. 2 Sts. 13 x and every 4 Rs 2 Sts. 5x]. At R 230 (236) [242] [250] transfer RB Sts. to MB and knit last row at T 10 and BOLT.

SLEEVE CUFF: Make 2.

With Col. 1 and 3 CO 50 (52) [56] [60] Sts. for FNR. After selvedge, RC 0. T 1/1 I. Knit to R 44 following Rib Color Chart. Transfer RB Sts. to MB. With purl side facing, rehang lower edge of sleeve on these ndls, decr. evenly across. Knit 1 R at T 10 and BOLT.

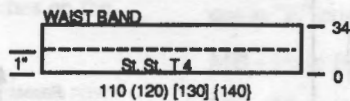
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SKIRT FRONT:

With Col. 1 CO 152 (160) [168] [182] Sts. for FNR. After selvedge RC 0. T 1.1/1 I. Knit to R 120 and mark each side with YM for aid in seaming. At R 240 (266) [[274]] mark each side with a YM and begin dec. on each side



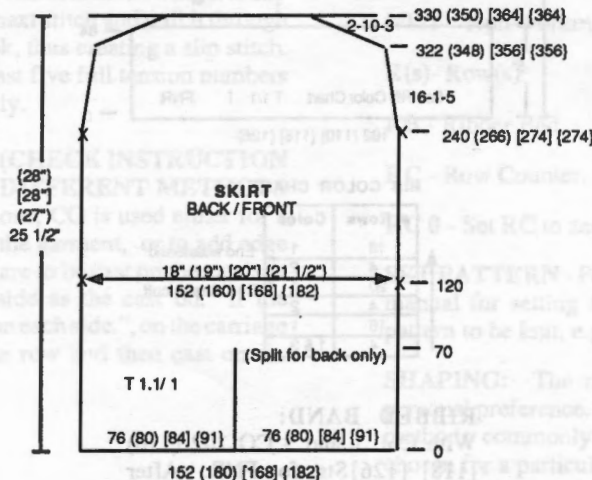
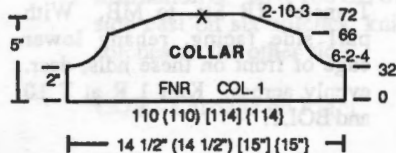
every 16 Rs. 1 St. 5x. At R 322 (348) [[356]] SHR on each side EOR 10 Sts. 3x. At R 330 (350) [[364]] remove on WY.

SKIRT BACK:

With Col. 1 CO 76 (80) [84] [91] Sts. to the right of '0' for FNR. After selvedge RC 0. T 1.1/1 I. Knit to R 70 and remove sts. on WY. CO 76 (80) [84] [91] Sts. to the left of '0' and work the same as the first section to R 70. With purl side facing rehang the first section. There will be a total of 152 (160) [168] [182] Sts. Complete same as skirt front.

COLLAR:

With Col. 1 CO 110 (110) [114] [114] Sts. for FNR. After selvedge RC 0. T 1/1 I. Knit to R 32 and shape collar. On each side dec. every 6 Rs. 2 St. 4x. Knit to R 66. Begin SHR shaping EOR 10 Sts. 3x. At R 72 mark center and transfer RB Sts. to MB. Remove remaining Sts. on WY.



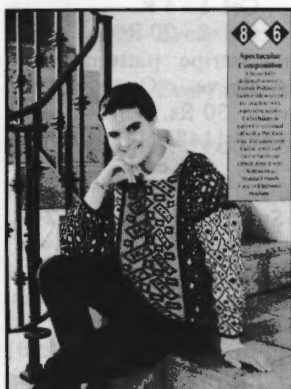
WAISTBAND: Make 2

Bring 110 (120) [130] [140] ndls to WP. With purl side facing rehang front/back of skirt on these ndls. dec. evenly across. RC 0. T 4. St. St. Col. 1. Knit to R 34. Pick up sts. from first row to form doubled band. Knit 1 R across at T 10 and BOLT.

FINISHING:

Close all seams and attach collar. For collar: Leave 2 1/2 inches from front edge before beginning to attach collar. Continue around collar edge to same distance of remaining side. Fold for lapels.

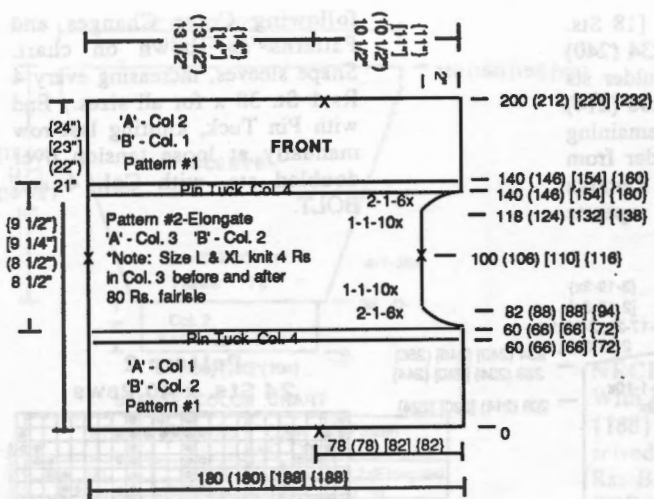

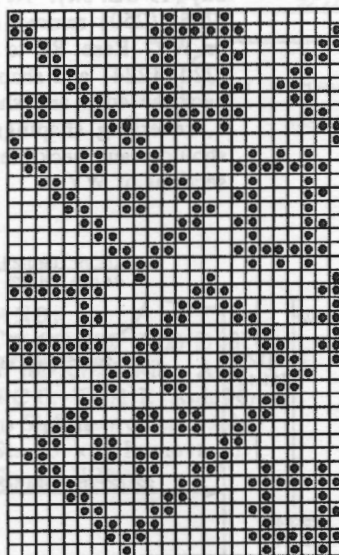
FRONT:

With WY CO 180 (180) [188] [188] Sts. After several rows, end with 1 row Ravel Cord to the left. Mark armhole with YM 78 (78) [82] [82] sts. from right edge. Change to Col. 1. RC 0. T 8. Set fairisle pattern for fairisle. Add Col. 2 in 'B' feeder. Knit in Pattern #1 to R 60 (66)

[66] [72]. Change to Col. 4. T 7. St. St. Turn off RC. Knit 8 Rs. for pin tuck. Pick up sts. from first row of Col. 4 to hang pin tuck. Change to Col. 3 in 'A' feeder. T 8. Activate RC. (Note for L and XL size: Knit 4 Rs of Col. 3 in St. St. before and after 80 Rs of fairisle in middle section). Knit in fairisle pattern #2 (elongate) with Col. 2 in 'B' feeder. After pin tuck begin neckline shaping on right edge. Dec. EOR 1 St. 6 x and every row 1 St. 10 x for all sizes. Knit straight to R 100 (106) [110] [116] and mark each side with YM for center. Knit to R 118 (124) [132] [138] and complete neckline shaping by incr. every row 1 St. 10 x and EOR 1 St. 6x. At R 140 (146) [154] [160] change to Col. 4. St. St. T 7. Turn off RC. Knit 8 R pin tuck. 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BUTTONHOLE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PATTERN #902

As usual fold the buttonhole section in half and turn the facing section to the wrong side thus doubling the buttonholes. Now join the open stitches of the buttonholes by weaving them together, first picking up 2 stitches from the underside (see illustration 1), then 2 stitches from the upper side (see illustration 2). Next, join the upper side open stitches to the under side open stitches until the entire buttonhole is woven together. Do not pull the yarn too tightly. Illustration 3 shows the finished buttonhole.

INCREASES AND DECREASES USING A RIBBER

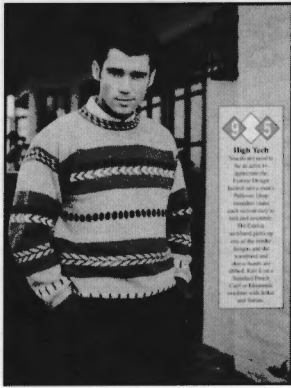
TO INCREASE:

As you must know, end stitches most always are a knit (MB) stitch and there is no rule that you cannot have two MB stitches at the ends—so to increase 1 st. when working K1/P1 Rib, pick up a cross thread from below end st. on MB and place it on the next empty MB needle, on the side to be increased. Knit 1 R, then transfer the 2nd end st. (2nd from the outside edge) to the corresponding ribber needle and push empty MB needle out of work. You have increased 1 st. on knitter and 1 st. on the Ribber.

TO DECREASE:

To decrease 1 st. pick up the last Ribber st. and place it onto the end MB needle placing it in front of the needle latch (MB stitch behind latch) and knit it through by hand. Move this stitch over to empty needle and push ribber needle out of work, knit 1 row then transfer end st. to knitter needle, knit it through. Continue ribbing to next decrease. Each time, you will be decreasing 1 st. on MB and 1 st. on Ribber.

For double knitting, or other rib knitting, use the same method and you will find that your edge increases and decreases are nice and smooth to make it easier for seaming your garment.

knitknit technical tips

In response to several inquiries we've received regarding whether a pattern on a Compuknit III-formatted disk can be transferred to any of the other Compuknits, we've put together this step-by-step explanation to show you that it definitely can be done—To begin, format a new disk in your Floppy Disk Drive using the Pattern Design Computer fitted with the "Omni Cartridge." Select the proper Mode for your desired use (remember, though, a Compuknit III pattern may not be appropriate for a Compuknit/ST or Bulky due to stitch-width limitations):

Mode 1: For Compuknit IV or Compuknit/Bulky use.

Mode 4: For Compuknit/ST use.

1. Insert new disk into Floppy Disk Drive
2. Press #5 (Transfer Created Data)
3. Press #1 (Format external memory)

Remove the new disk from the Floppy Disk Drive. Check the pattern you wish to convert for Stitch and Row Size. NoteTrack, Pattern, and size. Using your Pattern Design Computer (still fitted with the Omni Cartridge) and Floppy Disk Drive . . .

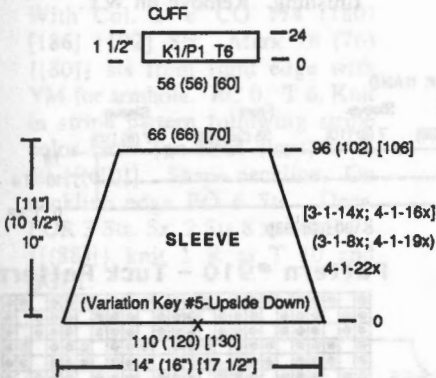
1. Select Mode 1 of Omni Cartridge
2. Create a new pattern in the stitch and row size desired.
3. Insert Compuknit III disk in Floppy Disk Drive.
4. Press "HELP" key. Press #7 from menu ("Load . . .")
5. Press "STEP". Choose #3 (From external memory - - - that's your Compuknit III disk)
6. Press "STEP". Identify Track and Pattern Number you are converting.
7. Press "STEP". Pattern will appear. SET CORNER "ALL" or partial pattern, as you desire.
8. Press "STEP". Grid will appear with cursor. Move cursor to place pattern where you desire.
9. Press "STEP". Pattern has been transferred. Press "1" if okay.
10. END CREATION
11. Insert disk you formatted in new mode into Floppy Disk Drive.
12. Save your pattern to newly formatted disk for future use (Do not be alarmed if this process takes a little while).

Pattern remains in Omni cartridge, until you erase it by placing another pattern into the memory. If you have saved the pattern onto the newly-formatted disk (as instructed in step #12 above), you need not be concerned about erasing it from the Omni Cartridge's memory—the disk is your "hard" copy!

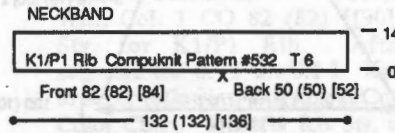
