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


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
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
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
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
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
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




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
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


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
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




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
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




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Description Book for Model Book No. 1

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Model Book No. 1

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Our first model book for PASSAP double bed machines consists of an illustrated book without text and a description book. This system enables us to have a large edition of illustrated books printed and to have smaller editions of description books printed in various languages. Thus illustrated books and description books, containing 60 PASSAP models, can be supplied at a very favourable price.

The new way of describing models by means of large patterns and little text facilitates knitting and saves you the trouble of too much reading. It is however important that you remember signs, abbreviations and tips right from the beginning, the meaning of which is explained on pages 1 and 2. Then you will see with one glance how each model is done.

Index : see opposite page.

Patterns: Drawing refers to half width, indication of stitch number to whole width of each part.

Figure I = back part
Figure II = front part
Figure III = sleeve
Figure IV = collar
Figure V = band, cuff
Figure VI = pocket
Figure VII = skirt, front
Figure VIII = skirt, back

Figure IX = pants
Figure X = gusset

If the central line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is done simultaneously with reversed shapings.

If the central line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is done separately with reversed shapings.

Stitch size: These numbers are recommended by us, but must be controlled by means of a test square, knitted on your machine with your wool.

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i.e. to all needles which are in Working Position on front and back bed.

Exception: For tubular, the necessary stitches are only given for one bed, on the other bed, the same number of needles has to be put into Working Position. In these cases, the sign for tubular ○ is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

+3x2•8.R

means: 3 times incr. 2 stitches in every 8th row
(1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front).

-19x3•7.R

means: 19 times decr. 3 stitches in every 7th row
(2 stitches at back, 1 stitch at front and vice versa).

-17x1•2./3.R

means: 17 times decr. 1 stitch, alternately after 2 rows and 3 rows.

▲-4x8•2.R

means: work with pushers and knit graduations (Lock BX). Gradually after every 2nd row return 8 pushers into Rest Position (for double bed work 4 pushers each on back and front bed). When all graduations are finished, put pushers into Neutral Position and knit normally with all needles and without pushers.

Number of stitches and inches:

136=8"

means: a total of 136 stitches (for K/K 68 stitches each on front and back) make a width of 8".

O 146=17"

means: cast on 146 stitches each on front and back for tubular which makes a width of 17 ins.

Test square and PASSAP chart

If you always knit 100 stitches and 100 rows for your test square, you save the trouble of counting rows and stitches and can read any desired measurement in our PASSAP chart (at the end of this book).

Horizontally: Across the top you will find the measurements in inches of your test square of 100 stitches and 100 rows; range from 4" to 20", split up in two charts.

Vertically: Required measurements in inches for your garment. From top to bottom, on the left and right, you will find the number of inches measured for your garment. These numbers range from 1/2" to 40" on each chart.

Example: 100 stitches of your test square measure, say, 10". For your garment, however, you need a width of, say, 8". Look in the horizontal column under 10" and in the vertical column under 8". Where both columns meet you find the number 80, i.e. you have to cast on 80 stitches (40 on each bed).

In the same way you find the desired number of rows on the chart. Numbers for measurements, which you do not find on the chart, you may obtain by a simple addition.

How to divide the work. Knit stitches, which should temporarily rest, like a buttonhole, with contrast yarn. Put the needles into Neutral Position. Thus you obtain long loops, which hold the stitches. Later on you just have to unravel the contrast yarn and the stitches will slip back to their needle heads.

PASSAP 12. Each model can also be done on PASSAP 12, if you choose a PASSAP 12 pattern. - Fairisle patterns can be done on PASSAP 12 with heel deckers, which are available at any PASSAP dealer.


Scarf, cap, mittens for 4 years approximately.

Materials: Medium sweater wool, appr. 5 ozs. red, 1 1/2 ozs. white.

Stitch size: 1:1 welt 2, stocking stitch tubular 5, pattern 4 1/2.

Test square: stocking stitch 100 sts. = 13 1/2 ins. 100 rows = 7 1/2 ins.

Figure XI: Scarf. Alternately knit 42 rows stocking stitch tubular, with slip stitch, unravelling contrast yarn, release. Fix sts. with transfer sts. for tubular by means of contrast yarn. B = at first knit 16 rows stocking stitch tubular, then three times 32 rows pattern, 42 rows stocking stitch tubular. Take sts. to strong yarn, pull together. Fix cord with 2 pompons between 2nd and 3rd pattern.

Figure XIII a: Mittens. A = 1:1, then transfer sts. for tubular, decr. 12 sts. B = pattern, knitting off the 4th to 9th sts. with contrast wool after 42 rows on back at left for thumb. C = pattern, decr. with double decker needle.

Figure XIII b: Thumb. Unravel contrast wool and hang the 11 sts. to the nds., the 4th st. being on the right (because of colour change). A = pattern. B = pattern, decr. with double decker needle. Knit left mitten as for right, but, knit off the 4th to 9th sts. on front at left with contrast wool. - Make seam on 1:1 welt.

Size: for 10 to 14 months.
Materials: appr. 4 ozs. medium baby-wool, 4 buttons.
Stitch size: stocking stitch 4 1/2, welts 3 1/2.
Test square: stocking stitch : 100 sts. = 12 1/4 ins. 100 rows = 9 ins.
pattern: 100 sts. = 13 ins. 100 rows = 6 ins.

Pattern: black strippers.

shift 2nd, 3rd, 4th patterning by 1 pusher to the right each shift 5th and 6th patterning by 1 pusher to the left each.

Figure I and II: A = stocking stitch, then put sts. on oddment of wool. B = stocking stitch, then bring to work sts. of A. C = stocking stitch, then take off all 120 sts. and hang to 80 nds. with plain side to the inside, decr. 40 sts. 1 row stocking stitch, one open work row, 1 row stocking stitch, then pattern. E = straps, pattern. Gusset: cast on 16 sts., knit 24 rows stocking stitch, cast off. Pocket: cast on 20 sts., knit 40 rows pattern, decr. on both sides 5 times 2 sts. in every 2nd row. Cast off. Leg welts: knit twice. Cast on 76 sts., knit 12 rows stocking stitch, 16 rows pattern. Cast off. To make up: Pin out parts to measure, press lightly using warm iron over damp cloth and join parts. Stitch gusset into position. Sew on pocket. Stitch leg welts to the outside of legs, then stitch to the inside. Crochet edges of upper part with 1 row of firm sts., crocheting loops to the front straps as buttonholes, attach buttons. Pull 31 ins. of cord through open work row.





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Size: for 11 years approximately. Materials: medium sweater wool, appr. 14 ozs. light blue, 1 3/4 ozs. black.

Stitch size: K/K 1 1/2, fairisle 5, Fisherman's Rib 3. Test square: 100 sts. = 11 1/4 ins. 100 rows = 4 3/4 ins.

Pattern: Fairisle according to diagram.

Figure I: A = K/K. B = Fairisle. C, D = Fisherman's Rib.

Figure II: A = K/K. B = Fairisle. C = Fairisle. D = Fisherman's Rib.

D, E = divide work, Fisherman's Rib.

Figure III: A = K/K. B = Fisherman's Rib. C = take all sts. to an oddment of wool and hang back distributed over 164 nds. (on front and back bed leave empty every 4th nd.), fairisle.

Fairisle: / = black, empty square = light blue.

Figure IV: Collar St.S. 3 1/2. A = tubular. B = K/K. C = K/K with graduations on both beds (pushers, BX/BX). D = 6 rows stocking stitch on front bed, 6 rows stocking stitch on back bed (GX/N - N/GX), then 4 rows tubular with contrast yarn and 2 rows K/K. Release.

To make up: Pin out parts to measure between damp cloths and let dry. Join side seams 1 3/4 ins. from lower edge, set in sleeves. Back stitch collar first to outside, then to inside, unravelling contrast yarn and crossing 1 1/2 ins. on front. Fold waist welt in half, making hem on the inside.






X = white, empty square = red. 1 square = 1 st. = 2 rows.







Test square: 100 sts. = 18 ins. 100 rows = 5 1/4 ins.




Figure IX/2: Leggings front. A, B, C, D = work as for leggings back. E, F = pattern.





Waist band: Knit twice. On front and back cast on 120 sts. each for tubular and knit 36 rows, knit a few rows with an oddment of wool and release.

Neck band: On front and back cast on 140 sts. each for tubular and knit 32 rows, decr. 7 times 2 sts. in every 2nd row on both sides. Knit a few rows with an oddment of wool and release.

To make up: Pin out parts to measure, press lightly using warm iron over damp cloth, join seams. Unravel oddment of wool and stitch bands into position, at first on the right then on the wrong side. Make hem of $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. on armhole.

Size: To fit a 36" to 38" chest. Materials: appr. 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ ozs. medium shetland wool. Stitch size: welts 4, pattern 4 $\frac{1}{2}$. Test square: 100 sts. = 15 3/4 ins. 100 rows = 8 ins.




Size: To fit a 34" to 36" bust. Materials: ca. 10 balls medium, mercerized cotton yarn blue, some white yarn, 20 buttons.
Stitch size: welts 3, pattern $3\frac{1}{2}$.
Test square: 100 sts. = 14 1/4 ins. 100 rows = 4 3/4 ins.



Waist band: For tubular on front and back in blue cast on 110 sts. for back, 60 sts. for front, knit 38 rows blue, then a few rows with contrast wool, release work.

Neck band: On front and back in white cast on 100 sts. for back, 50 sts. for front, knit 2 rows white, 36 rows blue, then a few rows with contrast wool, release work.

Armhole facings: Knit 4 times. On front and back cast on 70 sts. in white, knit 2 rows white, 18 rows blue, then a few rows with contrast wool, release work.

To make up: Pin out parts to measure, press each part lightly, using hot iron over damp cloth, join seams. Unravel contrast wool on armhole facings and stitch open stitches at first to outside then to inside. Attach buttons so that you can button them through the first pattern row.

Pattern: according to diagram. X = pushers to R.P. 1st series: pushers into R.P. acc. to diagram. 2 rows white, return pushers to W.P. 2nd series: pushers into R.P. acc. to diagram, 2 rows red, return pushers to W.P. 3rd and 5th series: as for first. 4th and 6th series: as for second. repeat 1st to 6th series with blue (instead of red).

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

Baby's jacket and bonnet.

Size: for 10 months approximately. Materials: appr. 8 ozs. fine baby-wool, 3 buttons, 47 ins. silk ribbon.

Stitch size: welt tubular $5\frac{1}{2}$, K/K 3, pattern 4.

Test square: 100 sts. = $11\frac{1}{2}$ ins. 100 rows = $6\frac{1}{4}$ ins.


