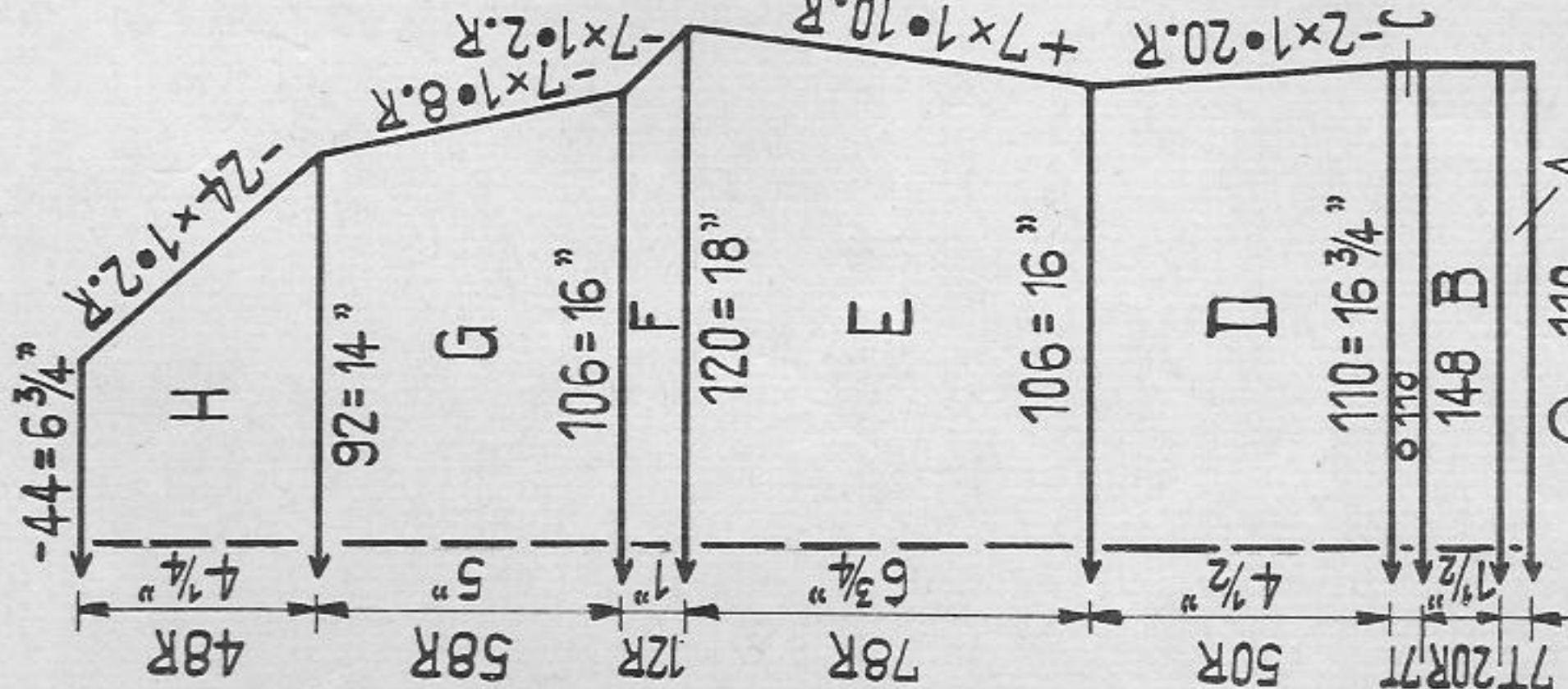


Fig. I: A = tubular. B = transfer sts for 2:2 rib, knit 2:2 rib. C = all nds for tubular in W.P., knit tubular. D = transfer sts for stocking st, knit stocking st. E and F = stocking st. G and H = stocking st. Decrease with triple decker.

Fig. II: A - E = as Fig. I. F = stocking st, decrease 7 times 1 st with triple decker. G = stocking st, H = divide work and continue knitting separately with reversed shapings, stocking st.

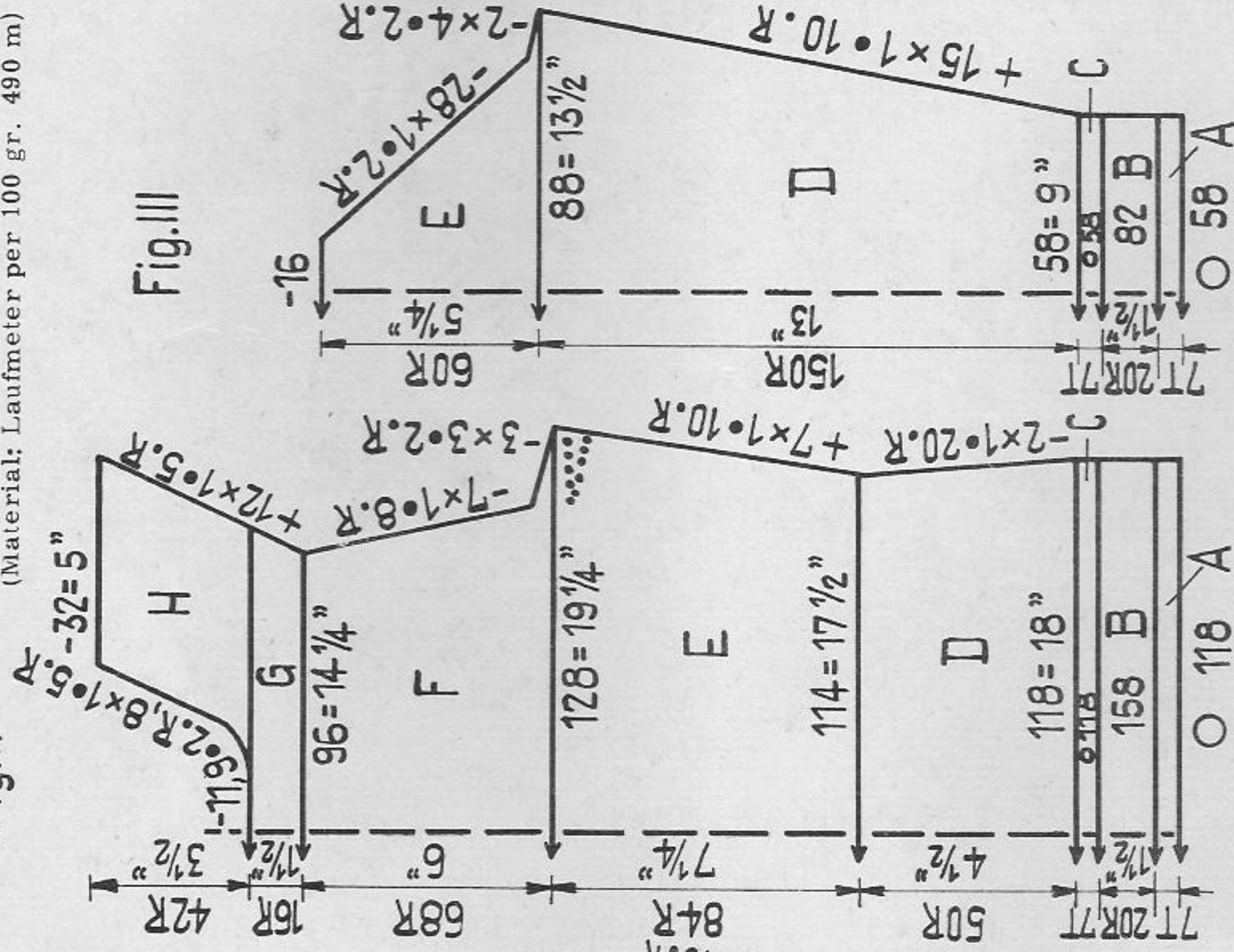
Fig. III: A - D = Fig. I. E = stocking st, decrease with triple decker. Collar: Cast on at back and front 106 sts each for tubular, Knit 14 rows tubular. Now transfer sts for 2:2 rib, knit 20 rows 2:2 rib.

All nds in W.P. for tubular, knit 14 rows tubular, a few rows with contrast yarn and release.

To make up: Do not press. Close side-seams, gathering front-seam at top to length of back-seam. See dotted line at E. Sew shoulders and set in sleeves. Attach collar first outside, then inside st by st with backstitches, unravelling contrast yarn.

These models are marked with an asterisk "\*" in the index as well as in the illustration book.

Please pay attention also to the wool sample card for comparison purposes, which comes in so handy when buying wool in your own country.

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Patterns : The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i. e. first knit one part according to diagram ( increasing or decreasing at right ), then the second part the opposite way ( decreasing or increasing at left ).

Stitches are only given by a number ( without accompanying letter " st " ). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or halftubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively ( or ) for half-tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

First increasing or decreasing always in the first row of a section.

- + 3 × 2 • 8 . R** means: increase 2 stitches 3 times in every 8th row ( 1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front ).
- 19 × 3 • 7 . R** means: decrease 3 stitches 19 times in every 7th row ( back 2 stitches, front 1 stitch or vice versa ).
- 17 × 1 • 2./3 . R** means: decrease 1 stitch 17 times, alternately once after 2 rows and once after 3 rows.
- ▲ - 4 × 8 • 2 . R** means: work graduations, i. e. short rows ( on DUO with pushers and lock BX ). Step by step put 8 nds ( resp. pushers ) into Rest Position 4 times each after every 2nd row ( for double bed 4 nds each back and front ). Once all graduations are finished, continue knitting normally , i. e. all nds in Working Position ( pushers in Neutral Position ).

Graduations can be knitted two ways, either from outer edge towards centre ( gradual decreasing with the minus-sign "-" after the black triangle) or from the centre towards outer edge ( gradual increasing with the plus-sign "+" after the black triangle.)

Number of stitches and inches:

- 136 = 20 cm** means: a total of 136 sts ( for K/K 68 stitches each on back and front ) make a width of 8 " .
- 146 = 43 cm** means: cast on 146 sts each on back and front bed for tubular which makes a width of 17 " .

Stitch size: These indications are only recommended by us. They must always be controlled by you making your own test square for your own wool.

Test square: We strongly recommend that you make always a test square with your own material before starting to work, in order to calculate for your material the necessary numbers of stitches and rows along the PASSAP - chart. The chapter " The test square and its calculation " in your instruction book informs you how to proceed for these calculations. This is very important, especially when transferring a model into another size.

To make up:

Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Sew parts of sweater together and set in sleeves. Attach collar first from outside then from inside stitch by stitch with backstitches, unravelling contrast yarn.

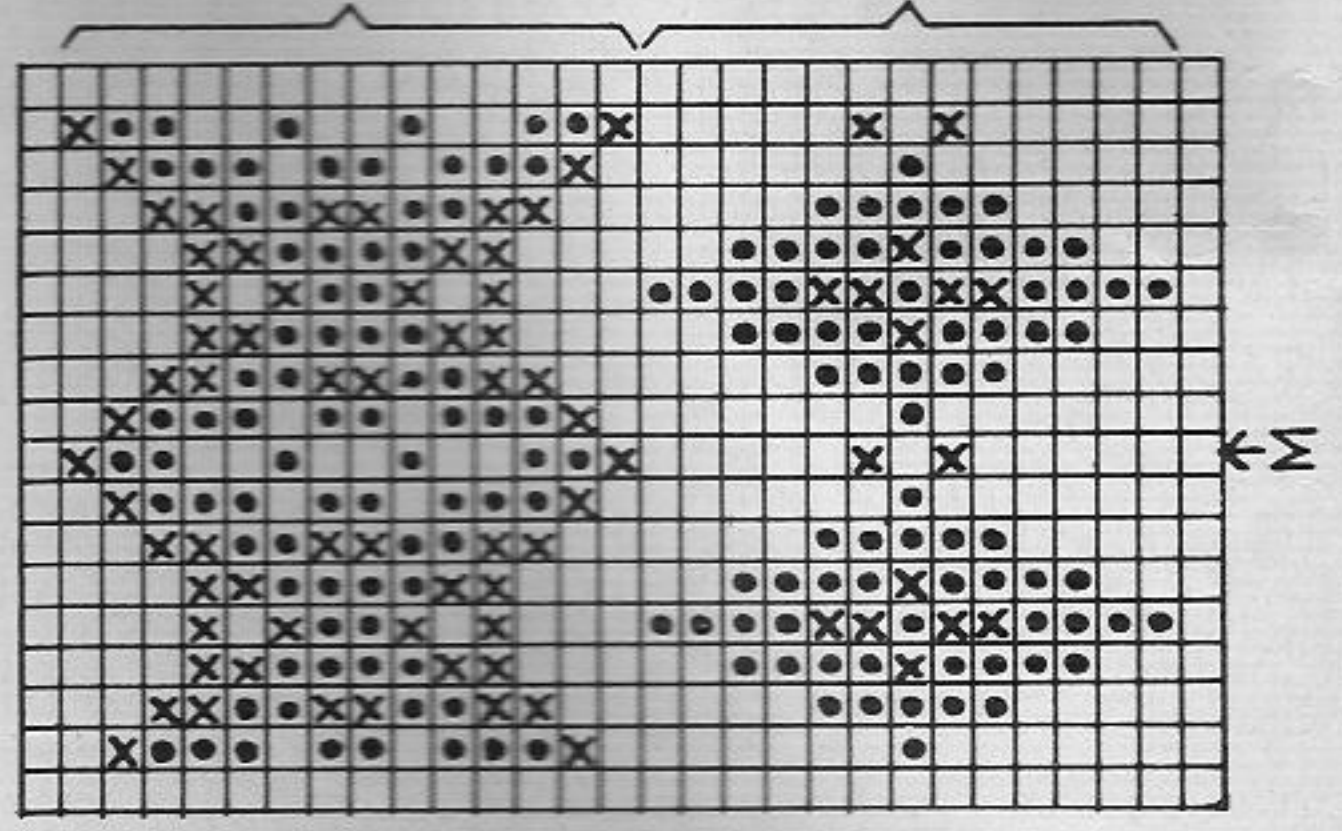

Fig. II: A and B as Fig. I. C = divide work, continue knitting separately with reversed shapings, Fairisle according to diagram alternately series 1 and 2. D and E = Fairisle according to diagram, alternately series 1 and 2.

Fig. III: A = as Fig. I. B = D = knit as Fig. I, however starting to knit with series 2 and alternately series 2 and 1.

Neckborder: Cast on 8 sts for stocking stitch with grey and knit 300 rows. Cast off.

To make up:

Pin up parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Close side seams and shoulders. Set in sleeves. Attach neckborder at front part first outside, then slip stitch to inside. Slip stitch also grey rows at neckline to inside.

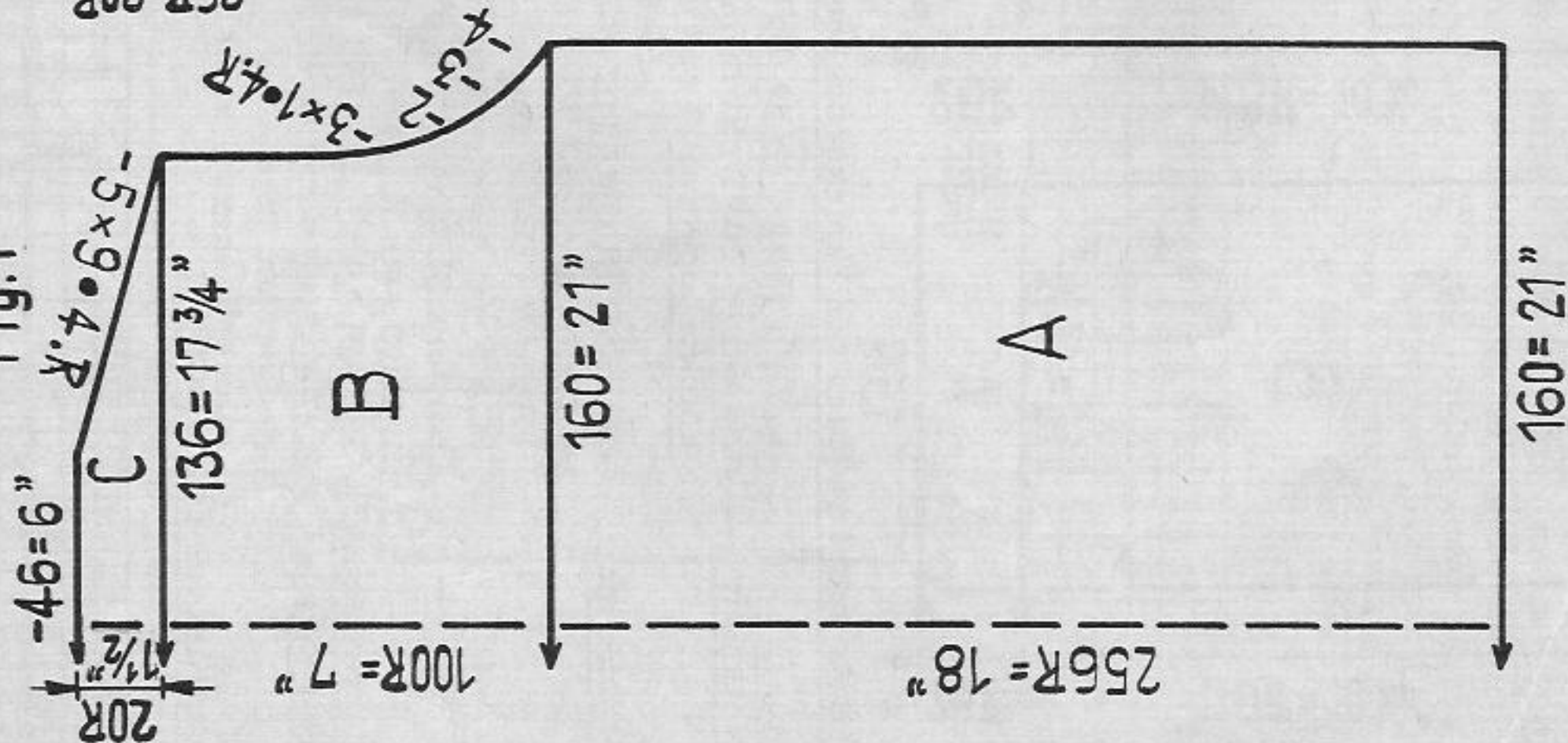

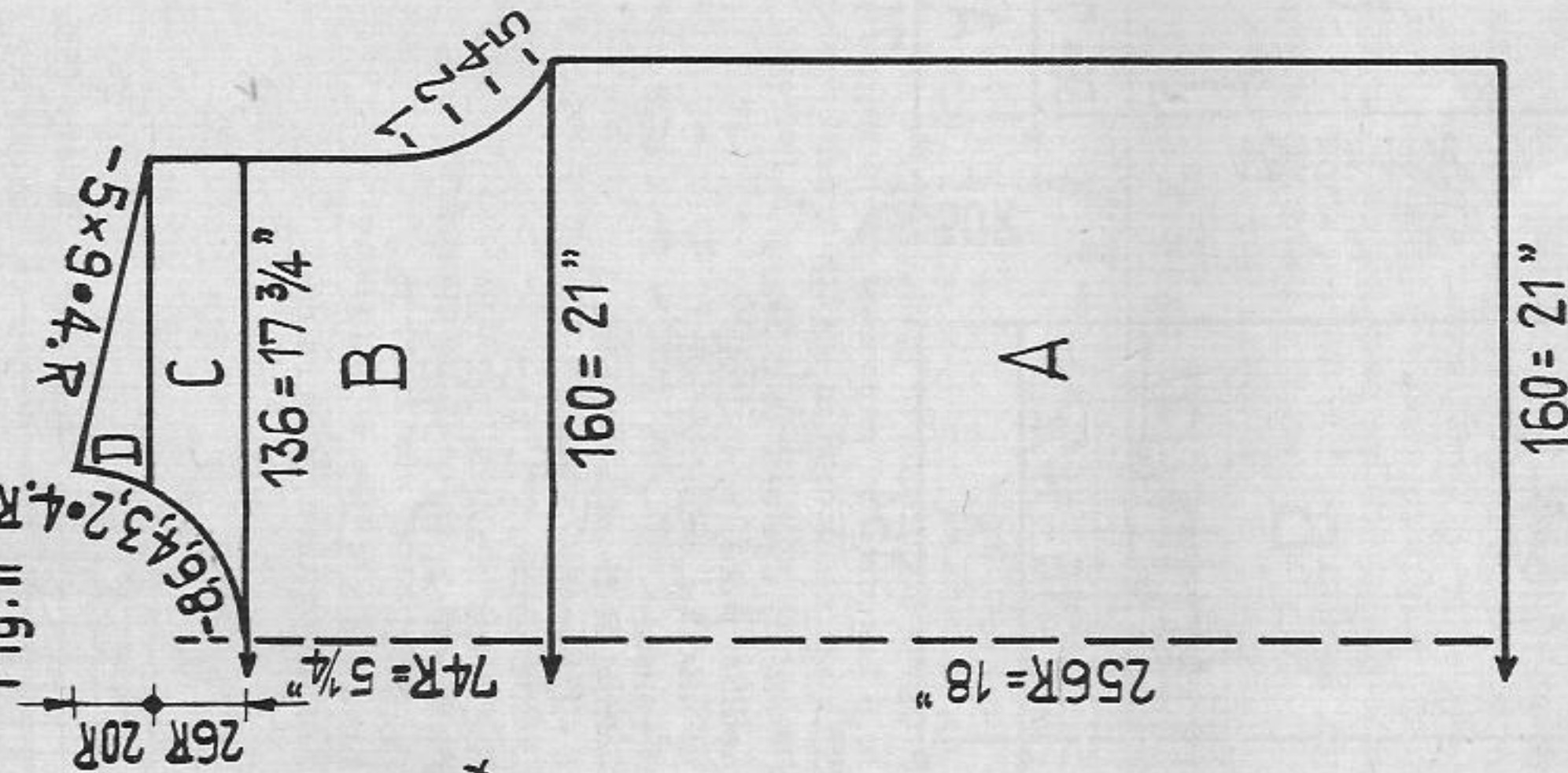
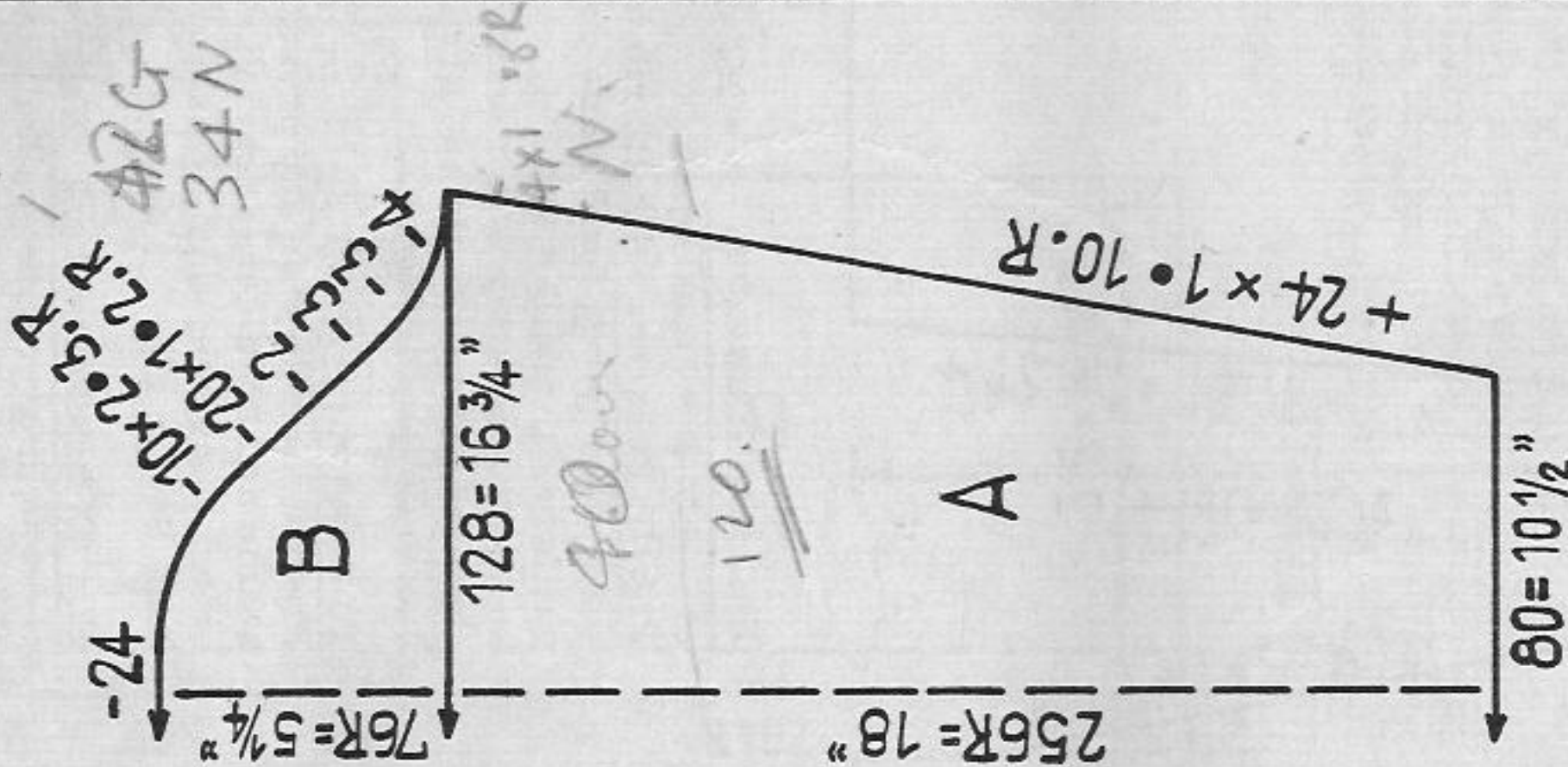

Close-fitting Lady's or Man's Pullover

Size: to fit a 39" bust/chest approx.

Material: 20 ozs of fine wool

Stitch size: PASSAP DUOMATIC 2:2 rib

St. S 3 1/4, tubular 4 1/2

PASSAP COMBI 2:2 rib

St. S 3 1/4, tension arm 2,

yarn brake 2 1/2, tubular

St. S 4 1/2, tension arm 9,

yarn brake 4

Test square: 100 sts = 13", 100 rows = 7"

Pattern: whole pullover in 2:2 rib

Fig. I + III : A to C = 2:2 rib

Fig. II : A and B = 2:2 rib. C and D = divide work and continue knitting separately with reversed shapings, 2:2 rib.

Collar: Cast on 160 sts for 2:2 rib. Knit 70 rows in 2:2 rib.

Then put to work all ends and knit 14 rows tubular. Knit a few rows with contrast yarn and release.

To make up:

Stretch slightly and press lightly with hot iron over damp cloth.

Close side seams and shoulders. Set in sleeves. Attach collar first outside then inside, stitch by stitch with backstitches, unravelling contrast yarn.

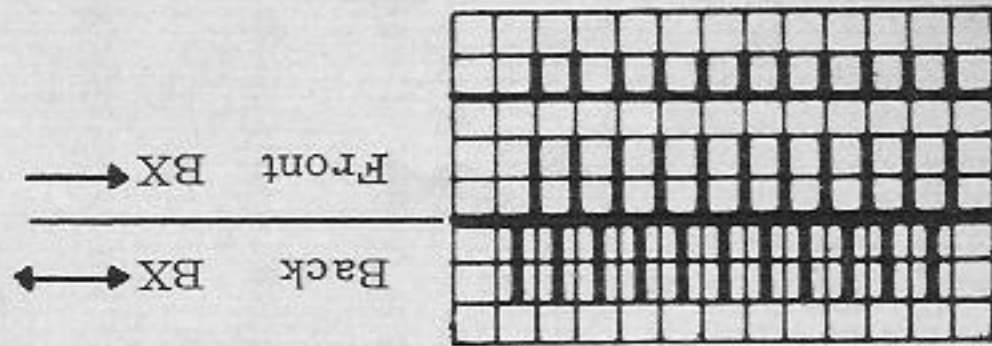
Size: length abt. 43", width abt. 36" (18")

Material: 21 ozs of fine Orlon yarn ( or fine industrial wool ) : 14 ozs red, 3 1/2 ozs each green and black

Stitch size: Pattern 4

Test square: Orlon : 100 sts = 7 1/2", 100 rows = 3" Wool : 100 sts = 7 1/2", 100 rows = 3 1/2"

Pattern: Handle down, red strippers



Knit two parts with reversed shapings

Cast on 260 stitches for pattern ( 130 front, 130 back ) and knit 60 rows pattern 2nd series according to diagram ( RC 1176 ). Once 3rd series according to diagram ( RC 1316 ) and finish off with 60 rows pattern ( RC 1376 ). Cast off.

To make up:

Press parts lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Make seam, leaving open the three series in centre. Crochet 2 rows of firm stitches with black wool at open edges. Make 4" long fringes with black wool around Poncho.

Girl's sport sweater and "knickerbockers"

**Size:** to fit a 26 1/2" to 27 1/2" chest, age of 7 to 8 years

**Material:** sweater: 10 1/2 ozs of medium wool, red, 1 zip knickerbockers: 7 ozs of medium wool, green, 1 elastic band

**Stitch size:** PASSAP DUOMATIC stocking st front 5 1/4, back 3, 2:2 rib borders 3 1/2 1:1 rib borders 3 1/4  
PASSAP COMBI stocking st front St. S 3, back St. S 5 1/4, tension arm 10, yarn brake 5, 2:2 rib borders St. S 3 1/2, 1:1 rib borders, St. S 3 1/4, tension arm 2, yarn brake 2 1/2

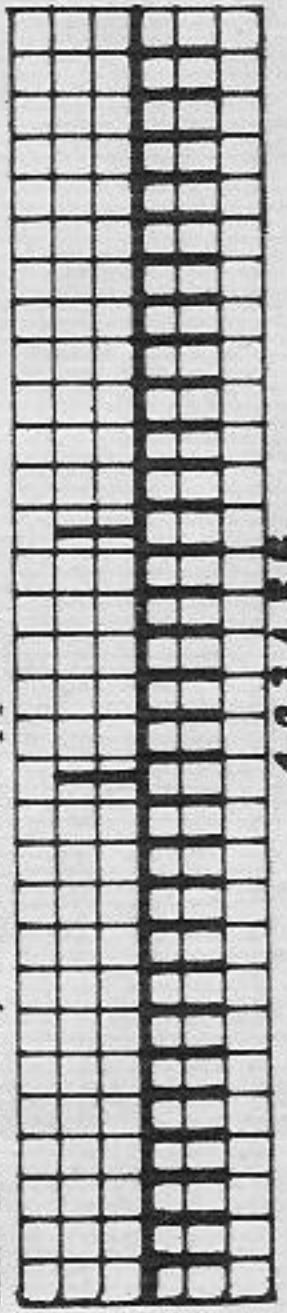
**Test square:** 100 sts = 12 1/2", 100 rows = 8 3/4"

**Pattern:** sweater: stocking st with cable pattern, according to diagram, red

Fig. I + III: sweater: A = 2:2 rib borders. B = transfer sts for stocking st, stocking st. B to E = stocking st.

Fig. II: sweater: A = 2:2 rib border. B = transfer sts for stocking st, at the same time arrange nds for 2 cable patterns according to diagram stocking st with 2 cable patterns, C and D = stocking st with 2 cable patterns. E = divide work, continue knitting separately with reversed shapings, stocking st without cable pattern.  
Collar: Cast on 32 sts and arrange in centre sts for cable pattern. Knit 144 rows, cabling every 16th row.

To make up:

Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Close side seams and shoulders, leaving an opening of abt 2 3/4" for zip at one shoulder. Attach collar to centre, then, flush with open shoulder, along the purl st to outside of neckline. Sew in zip.

Fig. IX: knickerbockers: Knit two parts with reversed shapings. A and B stocking st. C = stocking st with graduations from center to outer edge. D = stocking st, hem.

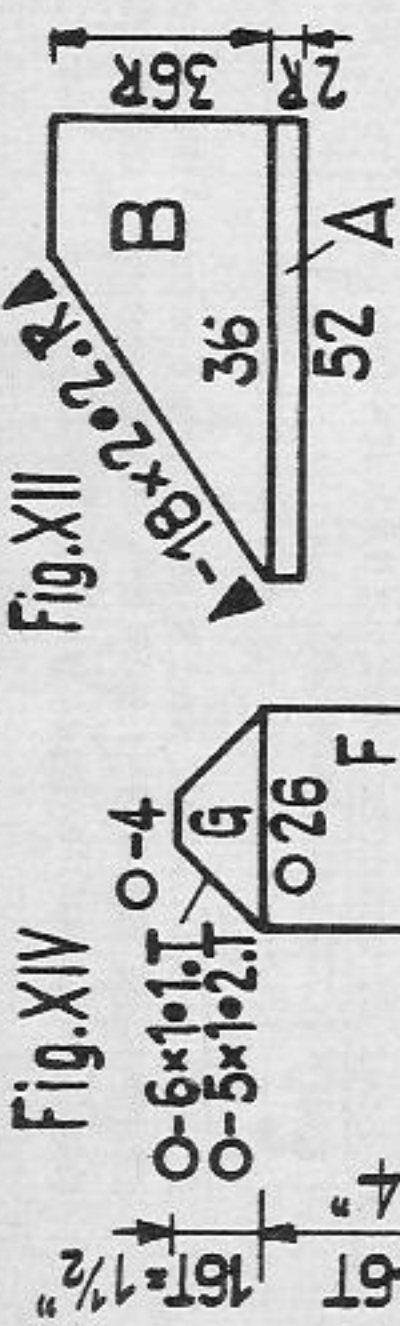
Now at lower edge (cast-on-edge) hang back to machine always 2 sts together in 1:1 rib (56 sts) and knit 30 rows in 1:1 rib, cast off.

To make up:

Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Sew together first each legging separately, then join both parts. Sew half to inside top seam and pull through elastic band.

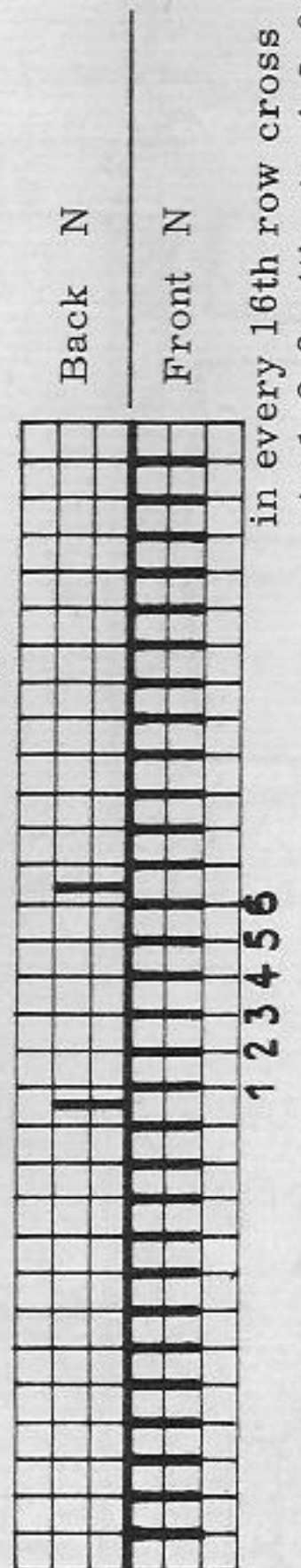


**Fig. XIV: knee length socks:** A = leg, stocking st., at end put sts on auxiliary thread. Turn leg (decreasing towards front) and put back the sts to machine. D and E = knit heel stocking st with graduation, first from outer edge inwards, then from centre towards outer edge, F = foot, stocking st. G = toe, stocking st. cable pattern band: Knit twice. Cast on 32 sts according to diagram ( in centre 6 sts for cable pattern ) knit 96 rows, cabling in every 16th row.

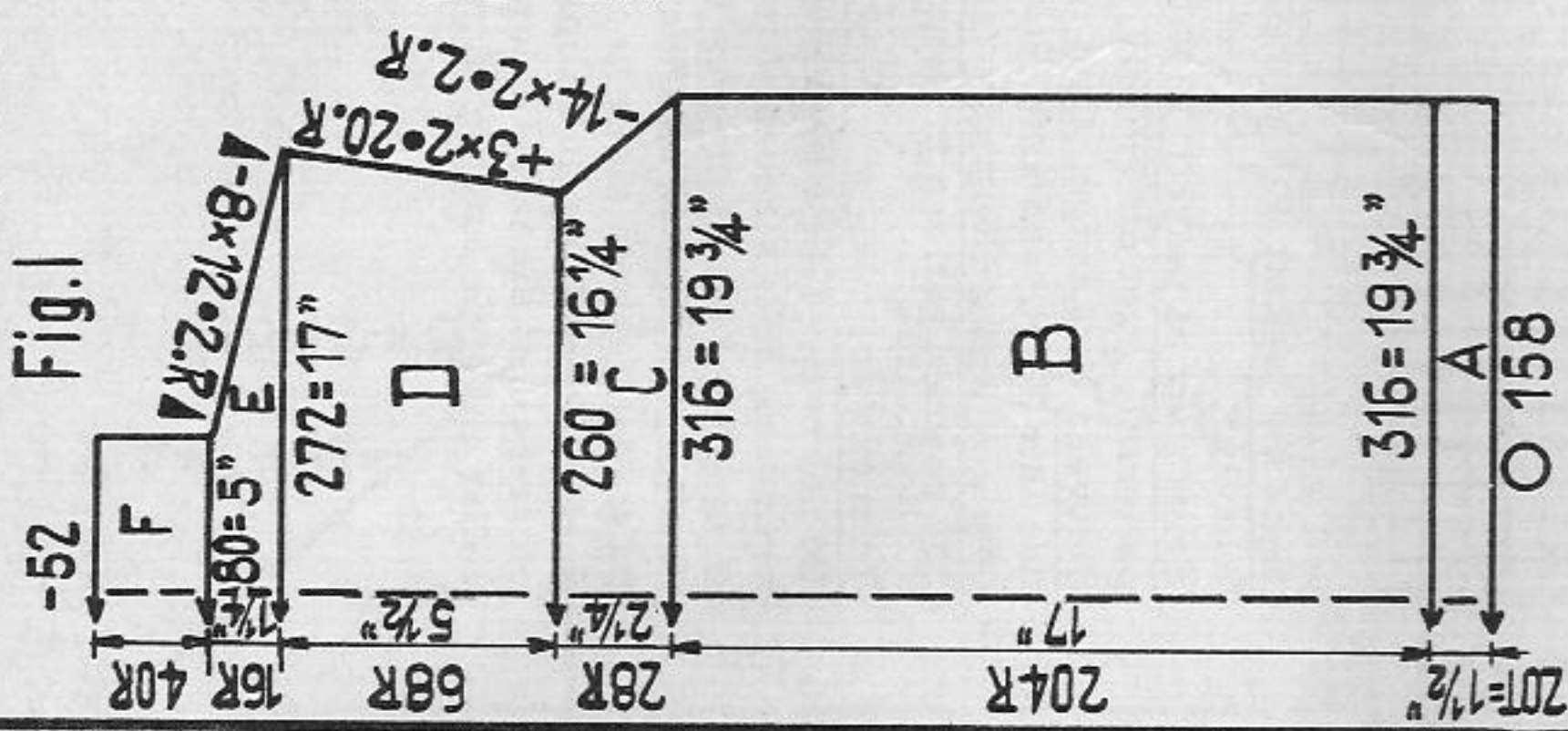
**To make up:**  
Pin out parts and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Join toe. Sew cable pattern band together with graft stitch, then fold edges towards centre and sew together. Finally attach band along the purl stitch row on outside upon upper edge of socks.

**Fig. XII: cap:** A = Cast on with contrast yarn 52 sts for stocking st., then knit 2 rows stocking st with red. B = pushers into W.P. lock BX and knit with green 36 rows stocking st with graduations, from outer edge inwards. Repeat 12 times whole procedure, total 494 rows.  
band for cap: Knit 224 rows with 32 sts in red according to diagram ( in centre 6 sts for cable ) , cabling in every 16th row.

**To make up:**  
Press lightly parts using hot iron over damp cloth. Sew together cap and capband with graft stitches. Fold long edges of cap band to centre and sew them together. Pucker cap to match width of band, attach cap band along lower purl stitch row to outside of cap.

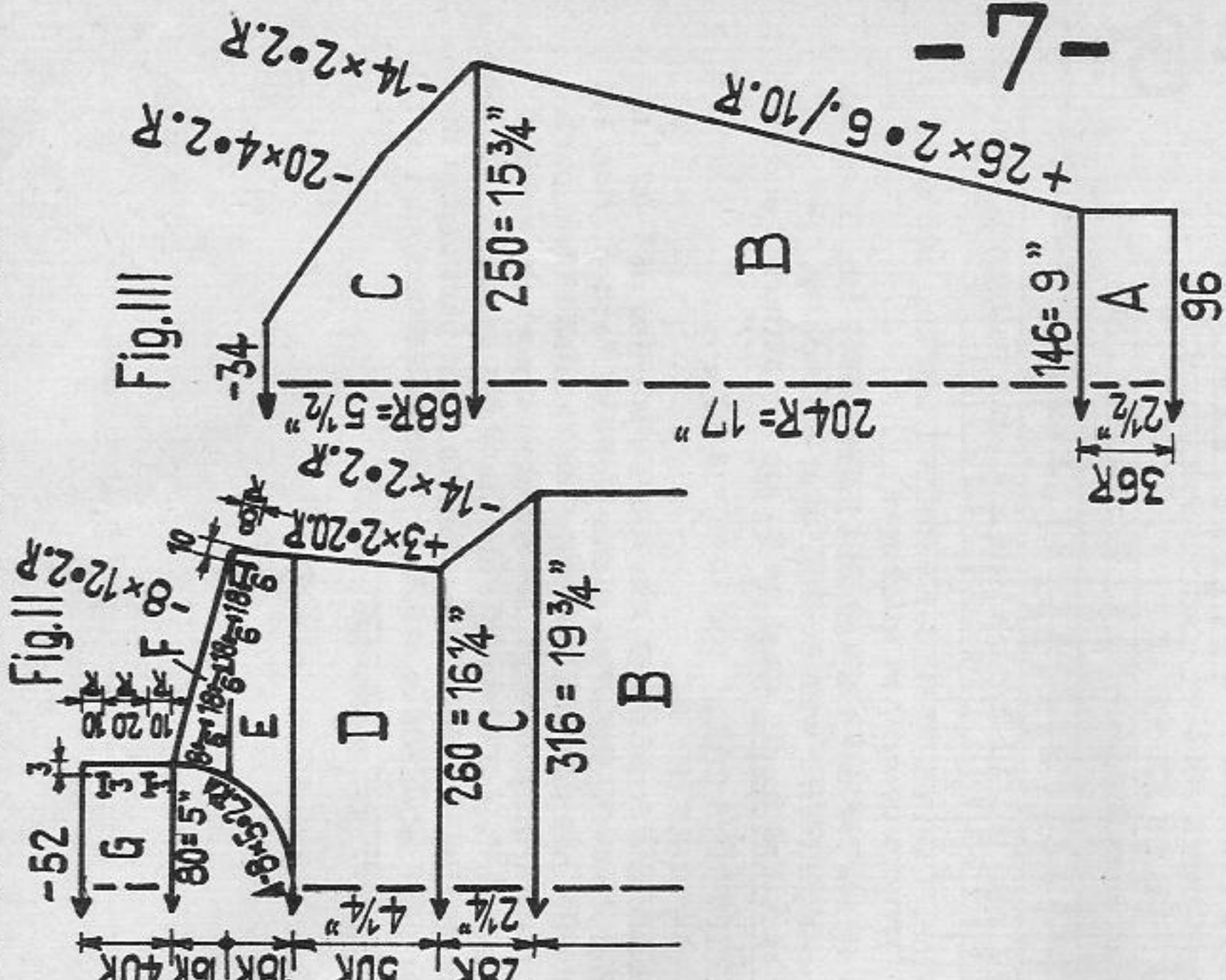
**Size:** to fit a 39" chest approx. Do not add any oversize at K/K

**Material:** 21 ozs of medium wool, 5 buttons

**Stitch size:** PASSAP DUOMATIC 2:2 rib and K/K 3, tubular 5.  
PASSAP COMBI 2:2 rib and K/K St. S 3, tension arm 2, yarn brake 2 1/2, tubular St. S 5 1/4, tension arm 9, yarn brake 4 1/2.

**Test square:** 100 sts = 6 1/4" , 100 rows = 8 1/4"

**Pattern:** Pullover K/K, pullover border tubular, neckline - and sleeve borders 2:2 rib



**Fig. I:** A = tubular, B - D = K/K, E = K/K, for shoulders decrease with graduations, at end cast off right shoulder and knit 10 more rows K/K for lower flap at left shoulder, then cast off. F = transfer sts for 2:2 rib, knit neckborder in 2:2 rib, then cast off.

**Fig. II:** A - D = as Fig. I. E and F = divide work (lock BX/BX). Knit first one half of neckline then other half in K/K. At the same time make 4 times each 1 buttonhole (according to diagram) at right shoulder : first buttonhole 10sts from edge in the 10th row, the other buttonholes, each 6 sts, after 4 rows. Space between the buttonholes always 18 sts. G = sts of both halves to be transferred for 2:2 rib, lock N/N, knit neckborder in 2:2 rib, making 2 more buttonholes at right, according to diagram. Cast off.

**Fig. III:** A = 2:2 rib border, B and C = K/K

**To make up:** Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Sew pullover together and set in sleeves. Sew neckborder half to inside. Work out buttonholes and sew on buttons.

**Fig. XI:** Diagram of a girl's cap and knee length socks showing parts A, B, C, D, E, F, G with dimensions and row counts. Part A is 32 rows, B is 16 rows, C is 26 rows, D is 26 rows, E is 26 rows, F is 26 rows, G is 4 rows. Row counts for various sections are 46T, 45T, 46T, 46T, 18R, 18R, 46T, 16T, 1/2.

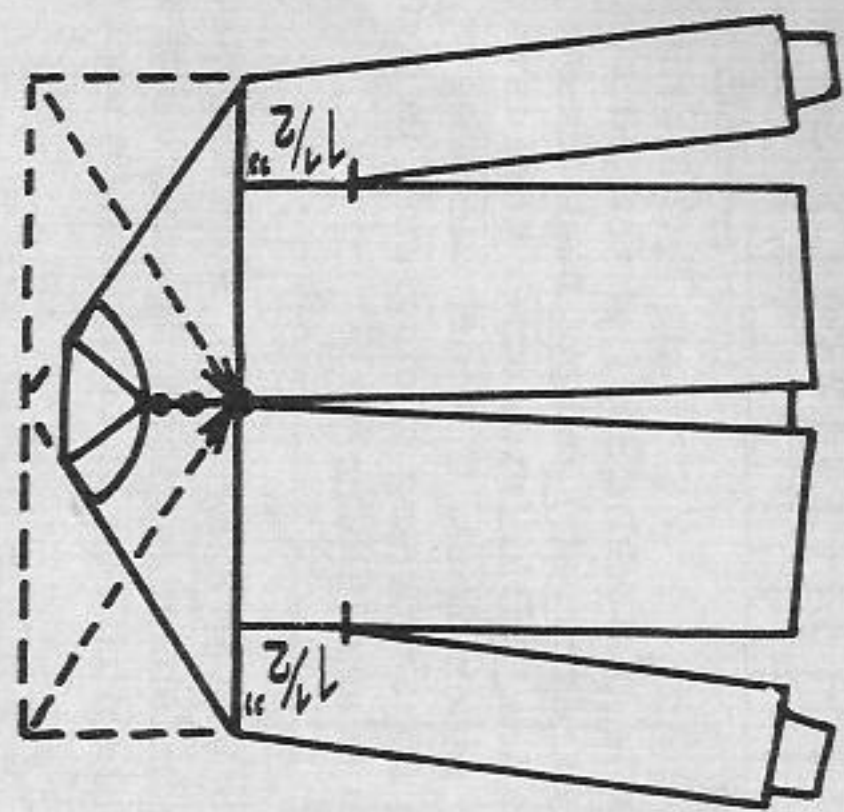
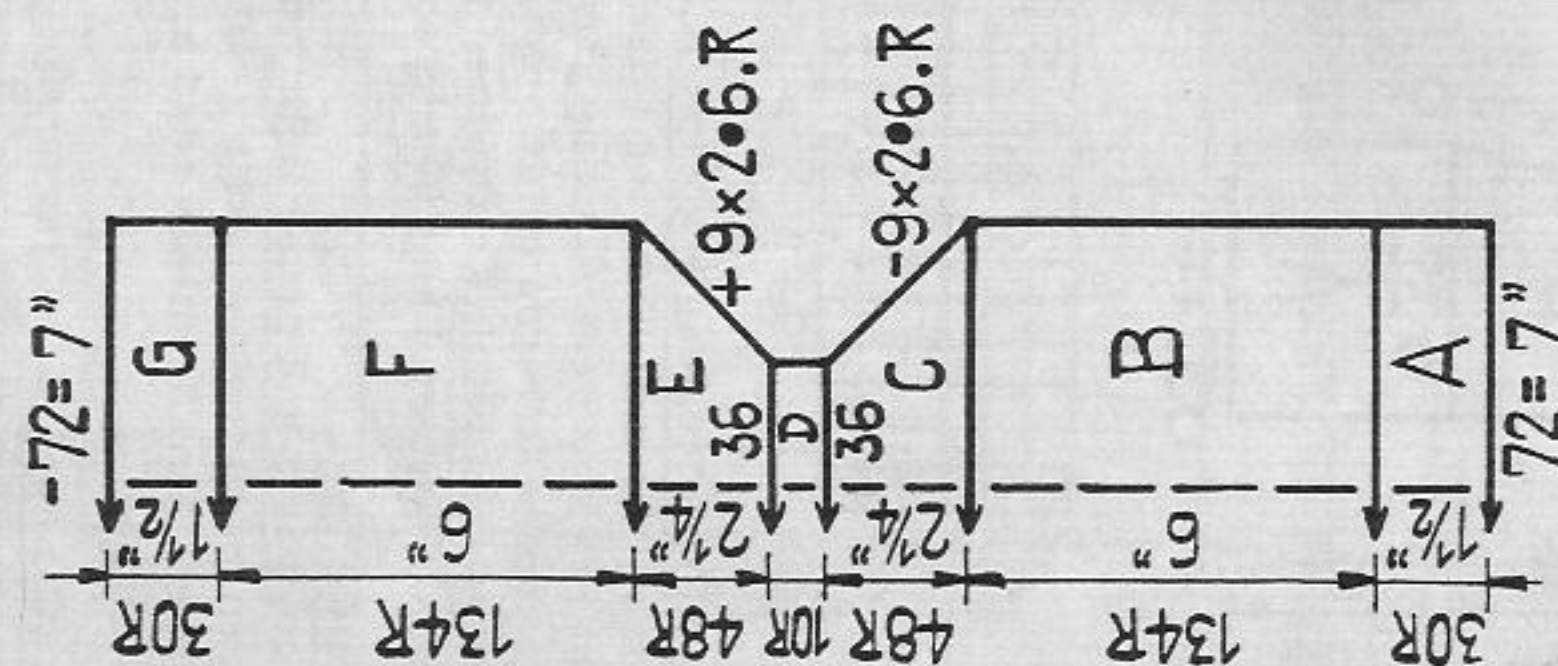

Bonnet: Cast on 28 sts for 1:1 rib, knit 16 rows 1:1 rib. Now put all ends into W.P. and knit 230 rows pattern 2, then transfer sts for 1:1 rib, knit again 16 rows 1:1 rib and cast off.

Border of bonnet: Cast on 120 sts for pattern 1, knit 42 rows pattern 1, 6 rows K/K and cast off.

To make up:

Fold bonnet to half and make back seam. Attach border of bonnet inside along K/K rows and fold it to outside. Sew towards inside the 1:1 rib rows and pull through silk ribbon.

Baby's outfit : jacket, panties, bonnet

Size: approx. 6 to 8 months

Material: 10 1/2 ozs of fine wool with glazed thread;

7 ozs for jacket, 1 1/2 ozs for bonnet, 2 ozs for panties, 1 elastic band, 1 silk ribbon, 3 small buttons

Stitch size: Pattern 1 : St. S 3, pattern 2 : St. S 2 1/2, 1:1 rib and K/K St. S 2

Test square: Pattern 1 : 100 sts = 9 3/4", 100 rows = 5"

Pattern 2 : 100 sts = 9 3/4", 100 rows = 4 1/2"

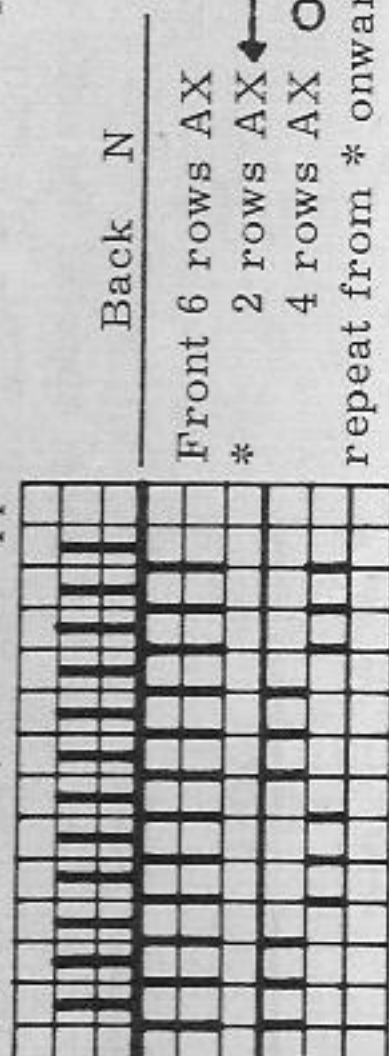

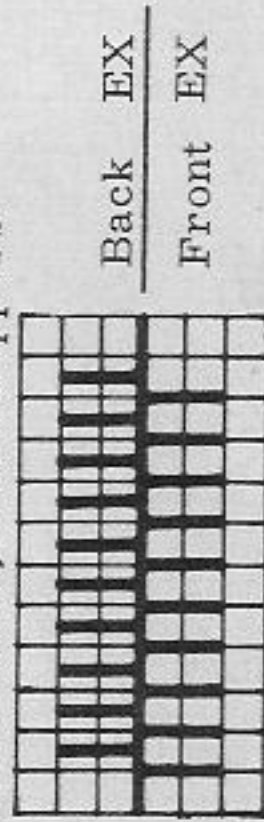

Back for jacket: For pattern 1 cast on 120 sts and knit 168 rows pattern 1, cast off loosely.

Front part of jacket: Knit twice. Cast on 60 sts for pattern 1 and knit 168 rows pattern 1, cast off loosely.

Sleeves: Knit twice. Cast on 40 sts for 1:1 rib and knit 30 rows 1:1 rib. Then all ends into W.P. and knit 160 rows pattern 1 with 80 sts, cast off loosely.

One single shoulder part for back and front: Cast on 60 sts for pattern 2 and knit 330 rows in pattern 2, cast off loosely.

To make up:

Do not press! Sew together back and front parts, leaving an opening of 1 1/2" at top seam. Sew sleeves together, leaving again an opening of 1 1/2" at top. Now set in length-edges of sleeves into the opening of 1 1/2" between back and front part. Sew length-edge of shoulder - according to diagram - first at the whole width of back then on both sides each to one half of sleeve. Fold the short edges of shoulder-part towards front and slipstitch, flush with front center, to front part and at the other half of sleeve. On lower part of shoulder attach 3 loops and 3 buttons and fold collar towards outside.

Start Fig. I + II (upper part of coat) with contrast yarn.

Fig. I + III: A = tubular, B and C = transfer sts for pattern, pattern.

Fig. II: Knit right front part with buttonholes according to diagram, left front part with reversed shapings and without buttonholes. A = tubular, B and C = transfer sts for pattern, pattern. D = divide work, finish knitting, first right, then left, pattern.

**Lower part of coat:** Knit back once. Cast on for tubular 178 sts ( front 178 sts, back 178 sts ), knit 14 rows tubular, then transfer sts for pattern and knit 380 rows in pattern. Knit front twice as back, casting on 118 sts ( front 118 sts, back 118 sts ). At end cast off.

**Neckborder:** Cast on 120 sts for stocking st, knit 20 rows stocking st, a few rows with contrast yarn and release.

**To make up:** Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Join parts, set in sleeves. Sew lower parts together. At side-seams fold one counter-pleat each reducing width of low part to width of upper part. Fix pleats. Unravel contrast yarn at upper part, place lower part between tubular rows and attach upper part st by st with backstitches inside and outside to lower part. Attach neckborder outside st by st unravelling contrast yarn, then sew half to inside. Stitch around buttonholes and sew on buttons. Attach fur trimming to sleeves.

**Hat:** Cast on 150 sts for tubular (back 150 sts, front 150 sts). Knit 20 rows, then transfer sts for pattern and knit 140 rows in pattern. Now transfer from front to back every 2nd stitch, put St. S to No. 3, lock to N/N and knit 20 rows. Now at back transfer every 2nd stitch ( 1:1 rib ) and knit 30 rows in 1:1 rib, a few rows with contrast yarn, then release.

**Ear-flaps:** knit twice. Cast on 60 sts for pattern, knit 30 rows in pattern, then in every 4th row, at both ends decrease 2 sts 6 times, then in every 2nd row 1 stitch 6 times. Cast off remaining stitches.

**To make up:**

Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Sew seam of hat and stitch together at top, unravelling contrast yarn. Cover button with fur and attach to top. Attach ear flaps and sew on fur trimming around the hat.

Pin out parts to size and press lightly using hot iron over damp cloth. Draw in lines according to dotted lines on diagram, then follow these lines with zigzag stitch and cut out. Cut lining material according to knitted parts. Now sew together the various parts (lining and knitted parts each separately) and set in sleeves. Attach collar, first from outside, then from inside, stitch by stitch with backstitches, unravelling contrast yarn. Attach trimming at front parts, sew in lining and slip stitch hems to inside of coat and sleeves. Attach 3 snap fastenings on front edge.

Fig. I, II + III: Knit all parts straight in pattern 1 and cut afterwards.

Collar: Cast on 250 sts for K/K, knit 30 rows K/K, 44 rows carpet pattern, 14 rows tubular, a few rows with contrast yarn, release.

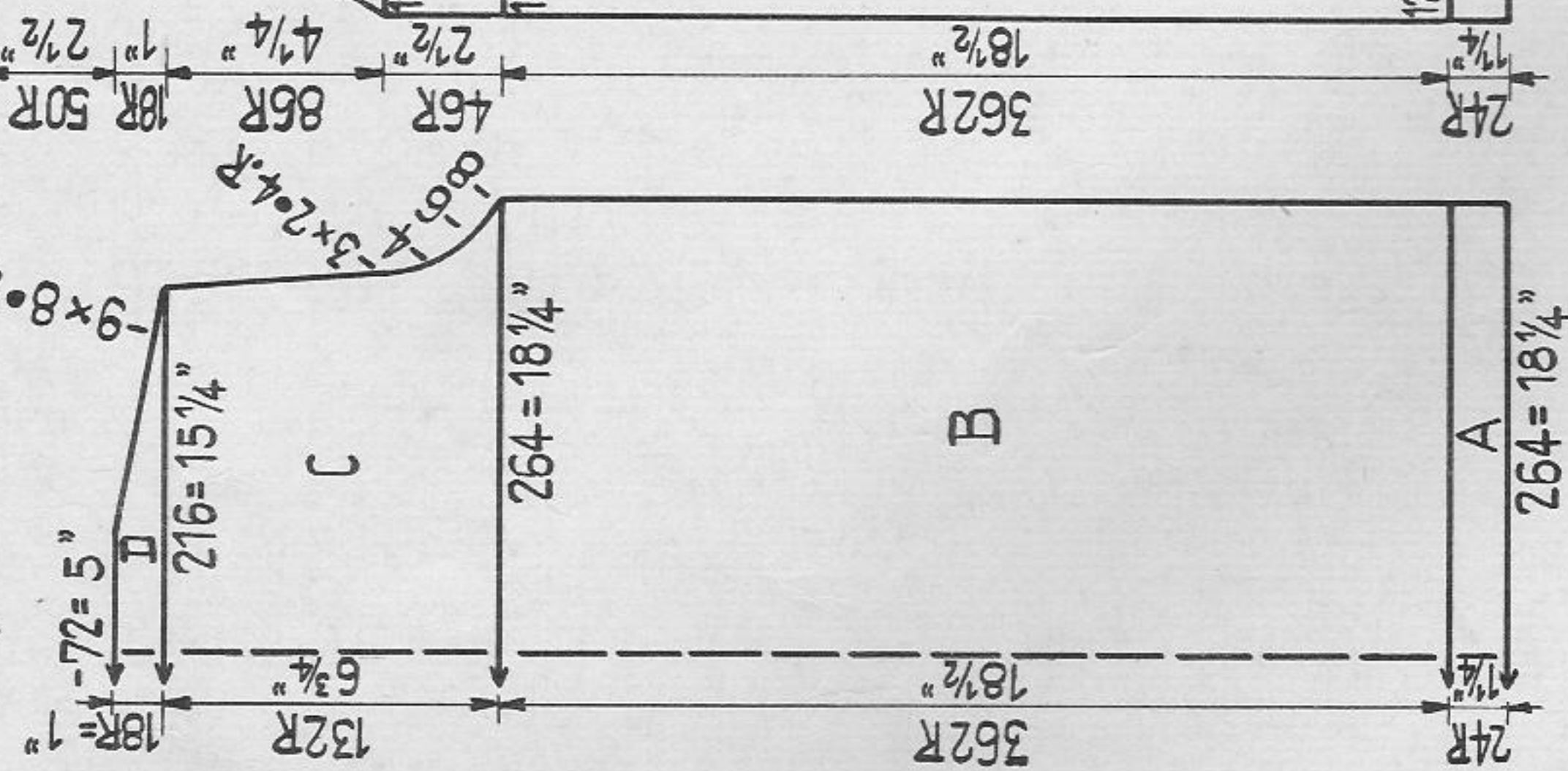

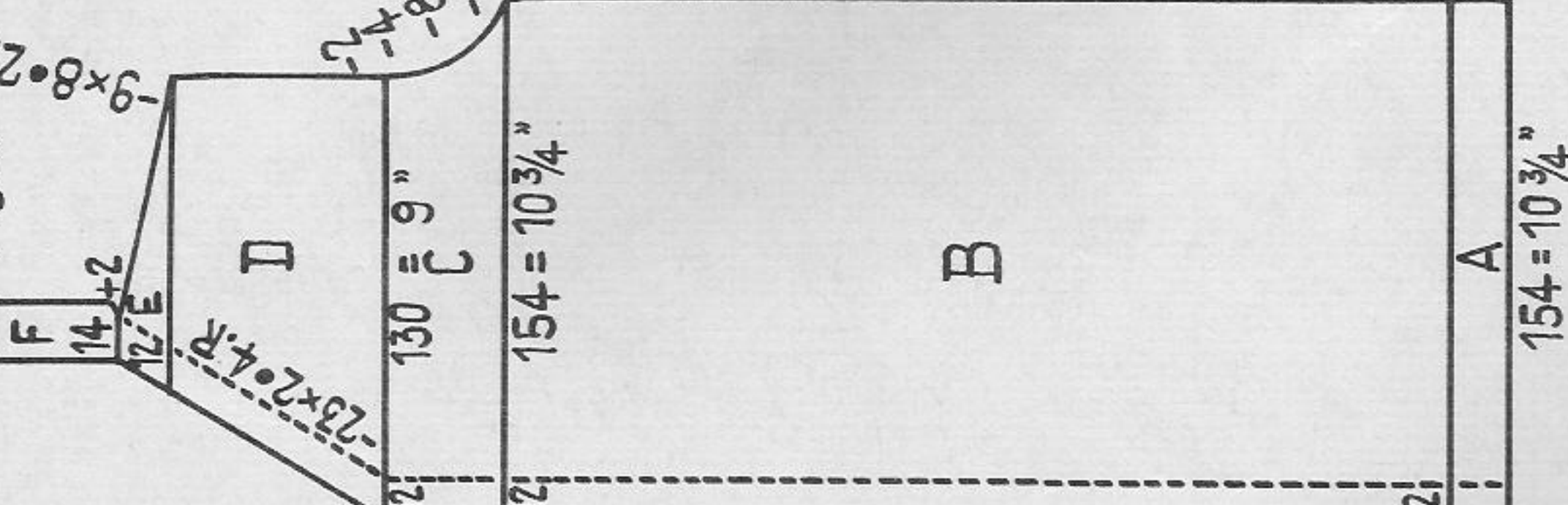
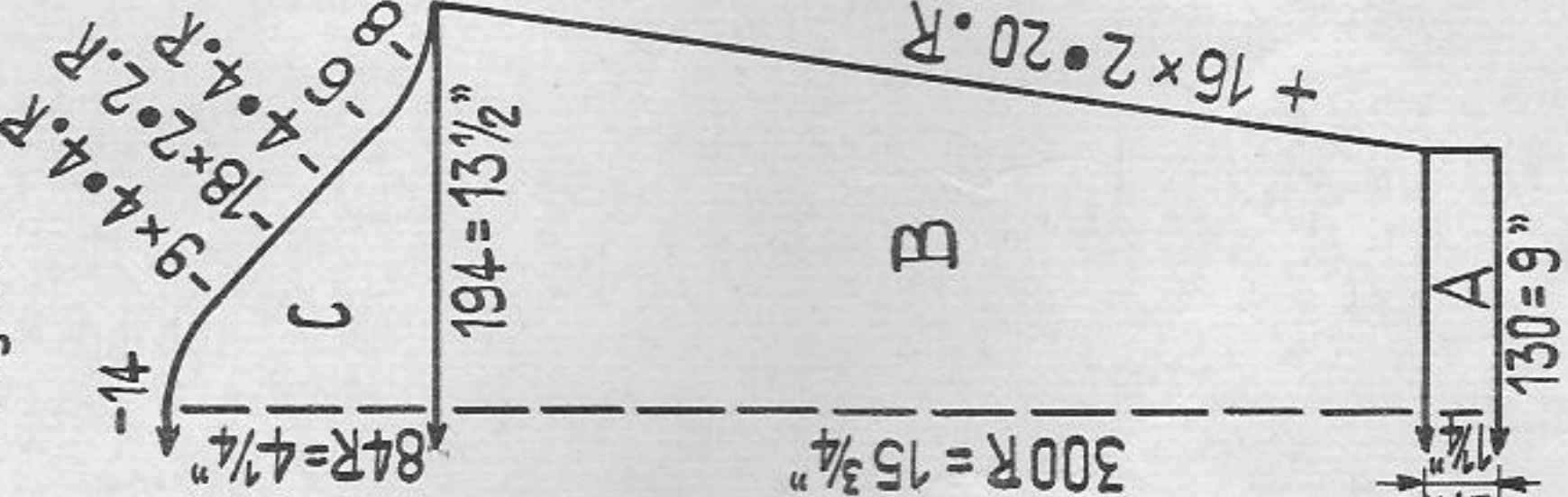
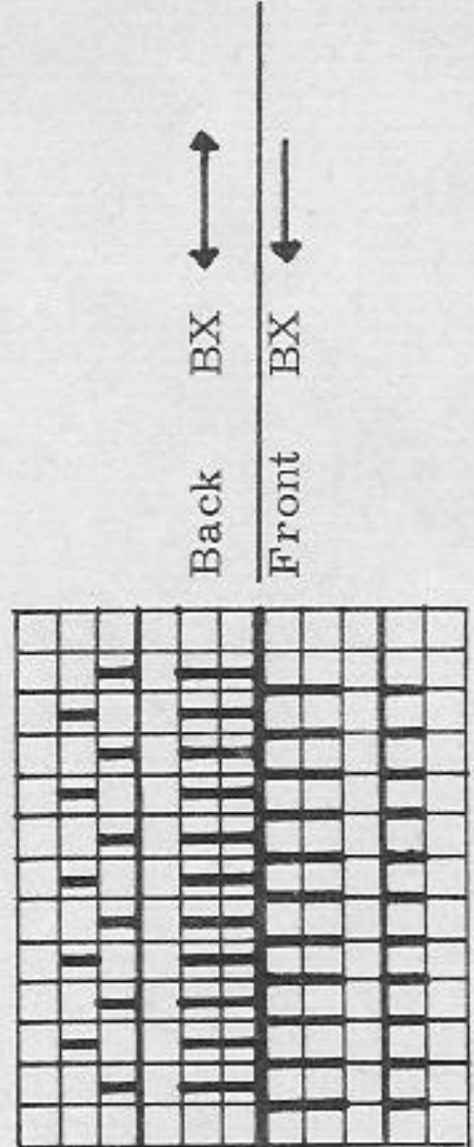

**Size:** to fit a 37" bust approx.  
**Material:** 21 1/2 ozs of medium wool: 12 1/2 ozs ochre, 9 ozs beige  
**Stitch size:** Fairisle pattern 5  
**Test square:** pattern: 100 sts = 7", 100 rows = 5 1/4"  
**Pattern:** Fairisle according to diagram with plain borders  
 Handle down, red strippers



**Fairisle diagram:**  
 Jac 40, pattern No. 15  
 empty square = ochre  
 X = beige  
 M = centre of part  
 1 square = 1 st = 2 rows = RC 4

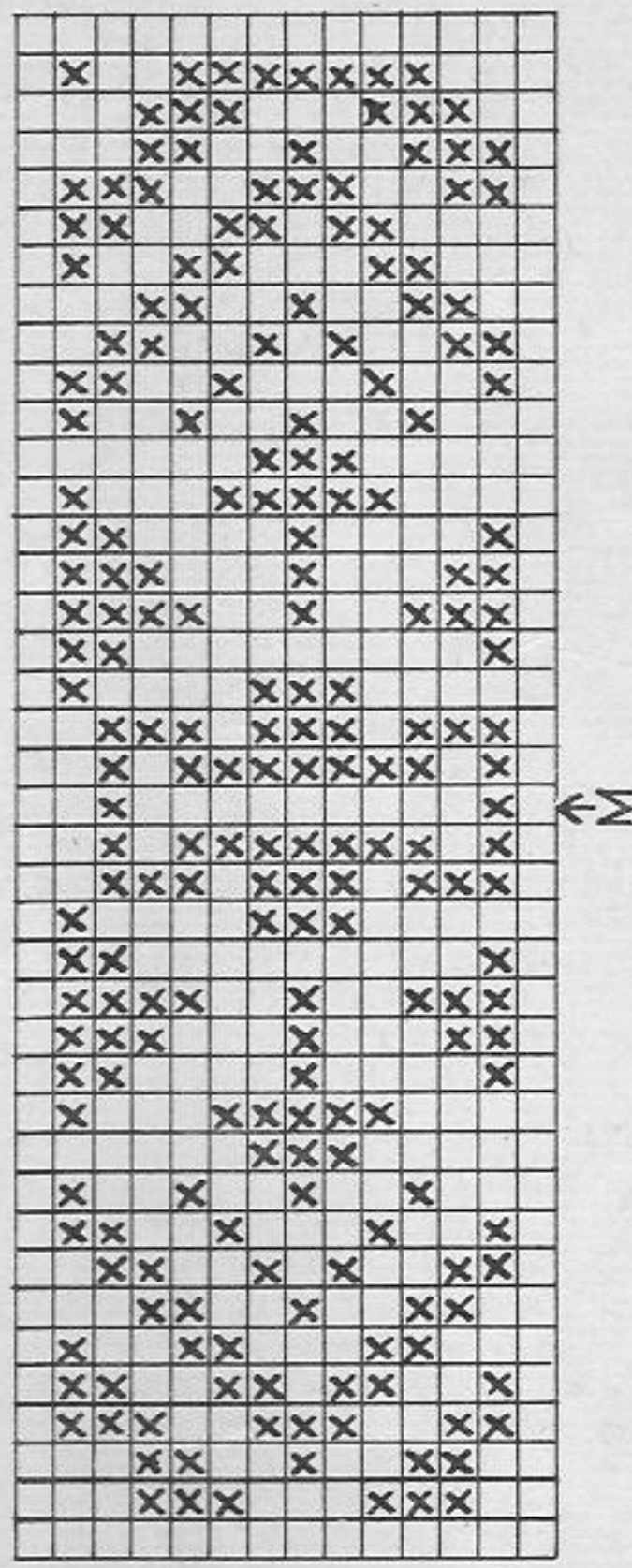


Fig. I + III: A = Fairisle pattern plain ochre. B - D = Fairisle pattern according to diagram.

 Close side-seams and shoulders. Set in sleeves. Sew neckborder together and attach at outside of the back.

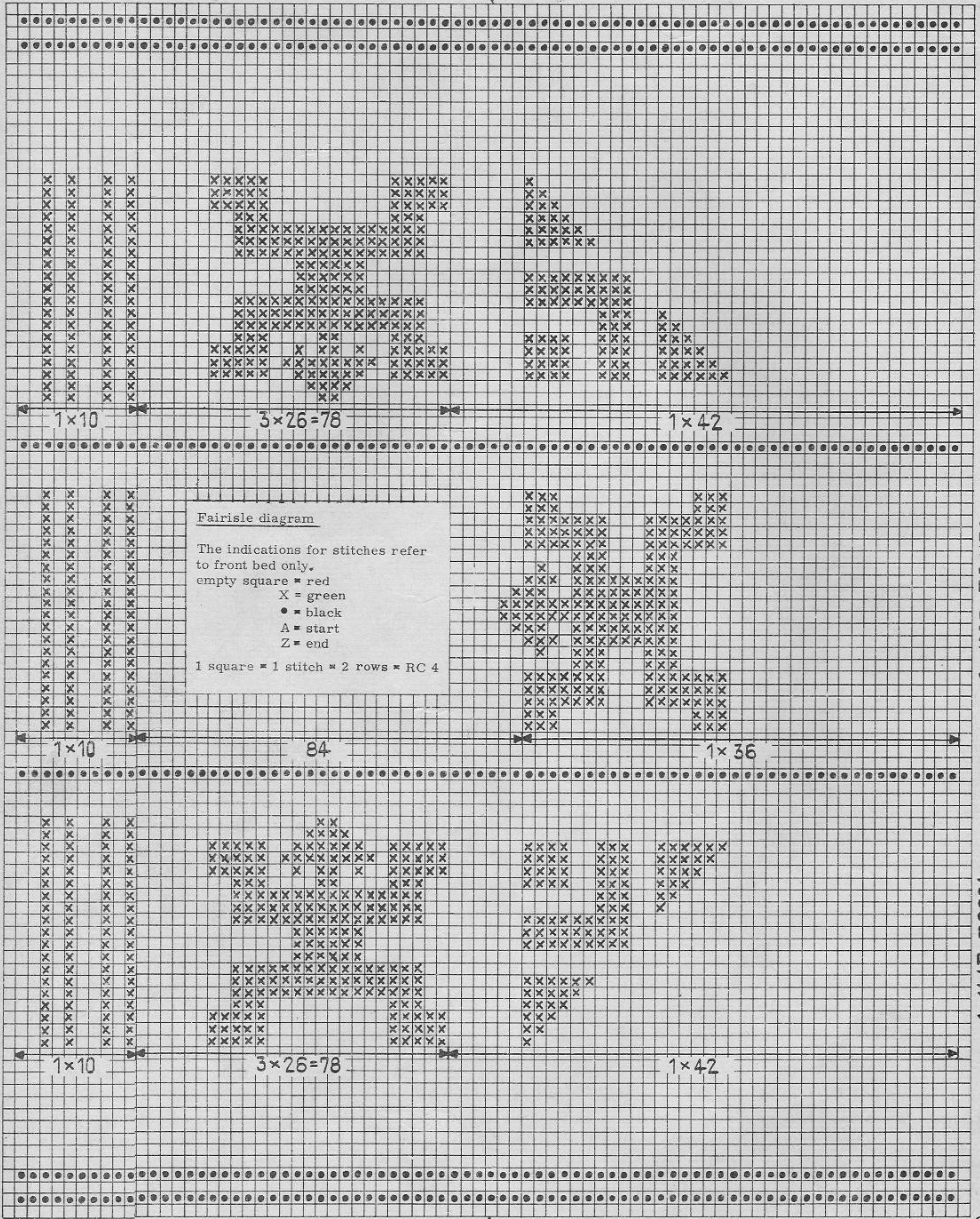
