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


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Description Book for Model Book No. 30

Garments from all over the world !

If you have already looked at the illustrated book, you may have noticed that some model numbers are followed by "Modelo I Lopes Portugal" or "Modèle Houriez France". These are garments that were lent to us by the above-mentioned PASSAP knitters. We would be delighted to have many more names from different countries for publication in our next issue. How about you joining in as well and make our PASSAP knitting book really international!

Have you knitted an attractive garment or some other useful or decorative item you would like to see in our book? Why not send it to us, either as it is or just a photo of it. But please remember that we would also like to know how it was knitted. And a test square and wool sample would also be most helpful.

We, and all the other PASSAP knitters, we are sure, are already looking forward to a varied truly international next issue.

Please read the following explanations before you commence your work.

Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i.e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i.e. first knit one part according to diagram (increasing or decreasing at right), then the second part the opposite way (decreasing or increasing at left).

Abbreviations:

Col.	= colour of wool.	O	= tubular (or) = half tubular
st, sts	= stitch, stitches	●	= every (in every row)
St.S	= stitch size	×	= times
Nd, nds	= needle, needles	+	= increase
R	= row	-	= decrease, cast off
T	= 2 rows	▲	= graduations (short rows)

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i.e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular O respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

First increase or decrease always occurs in the first row of a section.

+3x2•8.R means: increase 2 stitches 3 times in every 8th row
(1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front).

-19x3•7.R means: decrease 3 stitches 19 times in every 7th row
(back 2 stitches, front 1 stitch or vice versa).

-17x1•2./3.R means: decrease 1 stitch 17 times, alternately once after 2 rows and once after 3 rows.

▲ -4x8•2.R means: work graduations, i.e. short rows (on DUO with pushers and lock BX). Step by step put 8 nds (and their respective pushers) into Rest Position 4 times after every 2nd row (for double bed 4 nds each back and front). Once all graduations are finished, continue knitting normally, i.e. all nds in Working Position (pushers in Neutral Position).

Graduations can be knitted two ways, either from outer edge towards centre (gradual decreasing with the minus-sign "-" after the black triangle) or from the centre towards outer edge (gradual increasing with the plus-sign "+" after the black triangle.)

Number of stitches and centimetres :

136=20cm means: a total of 136 sts (for K/K 68 stitches each on back and front) make a width of 20 cm.

O 146=43cm means: cast on 146 sts each on back and front bed for tubular which makes a width of 43 cm.

Stitch size: These indications are only recommended by us. They must always be tested by you, by making your own test square for your own wool.





A = with 62 (67) nds in W.P. knit as for Fig. I. B = shape neck at left, knit straight at right, shape neck at left. C = knit straight at each end. Cast off.
Fig. V :
A = tubular cast on as for collar. After RC 12, make the first buttonhole as follows : at left, miss 3 sts, then at back and front, knit 3 sts with contrast yarn. Knit RC 36. Work second buttonhole as before. Knit RC 12, then a few rows with contrast yarn, release.
Button band : st.st. tubular.
With 12 nds on each bed cast on with lock N/N, St.S 1½. After RC 138 work first buttonhole : acc. to diagram, knit 3 sts by hand at back and front. Work 4 (5) more buttonholes every RC 70. After the last buttonhole knit RC 12. A few rows with contrast yarn, release.
Cast on : Cast on as given for buttonhole band. Knit RC 430 st.st. tubular. A few rows with contrast yarn, release. Press both bands, graft together upper edges, unravel contrast yarn around buttonholes and neaten the buttonholes using backstitch.
To make up : Block and press parts. Join shoulder and side seams. Backstitch button and buttonhole bands to front edges. Unravel the contrast yarn along the 27 released stitches on the collar, then sew the loose sts, st by st, backstitching into the open loops, first on the upper side to the narrow collar edges (gathering slightly at the corners), in the same way sew to underneath of neck opening, edges. Sew on collar, first on the outside, then on the inside of neck opening, st by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Join sleeves, slightly gather the lower edges. Sew cuffs, matching arrows and dots first outside, then inside, to sleeves st by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Neaten buttonholes. Sew on buttons.





At right, back and front, inc. 1 st every RC 4, i.e. transfer 1 st 1 nd out and place the purlstitch loop on the empty nd. At left, back and front, dec. 1 st every RC 4. B = straight at right, cont. to dec. at left. C = dec. every RC 2 at each end. Transfer all sts to the front bed and cast off together.

Waist band : stocking stitch, pale green, wool taken 3-fold. Begin and end with contrast yarn. Tubular, open at lower edge, cast on 106 (120) sts one each bed. Lock CX/CX, St.S 5, knit RC 64.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join seams, leaving an opening of 12cm on front skirt part, 8 cm below waist. St by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew pockets into the openings. Pull a thread through the waist edge, and then sew waistband first on outside, then on inside, to waist, st by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn.

Fig. III : knit two parts alike A = stocking stitch, tubular, with wool taken 3-fold.



For cast-on, knit 1 row N/N from left to right with St.S 2, then with lock CX/CX, St.S 5 knit RC 20 with dark green, RC 4 rust, RC 4 pale green, RC 4 black, RC 8 dark green. B = lock CX/N, dark green, with wool 2-fold, inc. at each end. C = shape sleeve head at each end. Cast off.

Fig. V : With 160 sts, St.S 5, knit 4 rows dark green, 2 rows black, 2 rows pale green, 2 rows rust, 10 rows dark green. With St.S 6½/2 knit 1 row dark green, with St.S 5 knit 9 rows dark green, then 2 rows rust, 2 rows pale green, 2 rows black, 4 rows dark green. For first border : at right, inc. 9 times 1 st every alternate row, then dec. 9 times 1 st every alternate row. Knit second border with reversed shapings.

Fig. VI : Number of rows and colour change as given for border.

Fig. VII : Begin with contrast yarn. Cast on 98 sts, inc. and dec. at each end as for borders.

Fig. VIII : Block and press parts. Join shoulder seams. Join the neckband and borders, then st by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling the contrast yarn, sew first to the outside and then to the inside. Join side and sleeve seams. Set in sleeves.

Neckband : Number of rows and colour change as given for border.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join shoulder seams. Join the neckband and borders, then st by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling the contrast yarn, sew first to the outside and then to the inside. Join side and sleeve seams. Set in sleeves.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join shoulder and side seams. Sew on neckband and armhole bands, first on the outside, then on the inside, st by st, backstitching into the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn.

 With 80 nds on each bed knit RC 24 stocking stitch, tubular.

Fig. VI : pockets, two parts alike
A = begin with contrast yarn, st.st. tubular, inc. at right, dec. at left.
B = knit straight at right, dec. at left. C = dec. at right and at left.
 Cast off the sts of both beds together, thereby joining the pocket.

Fig. I : with 280 (296) nds tubular cast-on with caramel. Then, acc. to diagram always leave 3 sts on front bed and transfer 3 sts to back bed. Knit straight in pattern. B = shape armhole at each end : on back bed dec. acc. to diagram, on front bed accordingly, putting the corresponding pushers into the blocking rail. C = dec. at each end. Cast off.

Fig. II : right front part
 With 188 (200) nds tubular cast-on with caramel. Then, transfer sts as for Fig.I. At left, to make the underlap for the front edge, transfer all sts to the back bed over a width of 14 nds. Knit straight. B = shape armhole at right, knit straight at left. C = knit straight at right; at left, for neck opening, first cast off 32 sts, then dec. acc. to diagram. Cast off. Second front part :

Fig. III : first sleeve
 A = with 168 nds tubular cast-on with caramel. Then, transfer sts as for Fig. I.

Knit in pattern, inc. at each end, at front putting nds and pushers in W.P. accordingly. B = at each end shape sleeve head. C = shoulder : dec. at each end. D = shape neck at right. Second sleeve : A, B + C as for first sleeve. D = knit with reversed shapings.

Fig. VI : collar lining
 Begin with contrast yarn. Knit straight st.st., caramel. Cast off.

Cuffs : caramel, begin and end with contrast yarn.

Lock at front N, back CX, 50 nds in W.P. Knit twice 110 rows.

Belt : caramel
 With 24 nds in W.P., lock at front N, back CX, knit belt to required length, cast off.

To make up : Block and press parts. Sew sleeves between back and front parts, matching dots and arrows. Joins side and sleeve seams. Using mattress stitch, sew collar lining to front parts, matching circles and crosses. Thread a length of yarn through the neck edge, following the broken line at the back as given in the diagram. Now, with right sides together, backstitch collar lining to neck edge, turn, and press collar edge slightly. Shape collar with four more gathered rows, taking care to always place the thread underneath the vertical stripes. At front edges, fold underlaps to inside and slip stitch into position. Sew on hook with corresponding loop to front neck. Gather lower edge of sleeves. Join cuffs in a ring and backstitch to sleeves, first on the outside, then on the inside.

Fig. VII + VIII : knit two parts alike
 A = with 272 (288) nds tubular cast-on with caramel. Transfer sts as for Fig. I. Knit straight until row 335. Transfer all sts to front bed and knit 1 row st. with St.S 5. B = waistband, caramel. At front and back 20 nds each in W.P., tubular cast on, knit 540 rows acc. to diagram. Then dec. 1 st at each end on every 30th row until 24 sts remain on machine. Then, with lock at front BX ← →, back BX ← →, knit 500 rows, cast off.










Diagram Black strippers






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
