PROGRAMMES FOR THE FORM COMPUTER

Looking through your description book, you will notice new columns of figures - possibly still meaningless to you - accompanying most of the garment descriptions.

In fact, these columns represent the programmes for the FORM COMPUTER, our new electronic shaping device, and the figures really contain the whole diagram as shown alongside them.

On examining one of these columns a little more closely, you will discover blank spaces with something written at the side. And always in the same place you will find "mm 40 R" and "mm 40 sts". These are the spaces provided for entering the measurements of your own test square, i.e. in millimetres for 40 rows or 40 stitches. Then, you will also find the expressions : "cm bust/chest" or "cm total length" at the side of empty spaces. They will take your personal bust measurements or the overall length of the garment.

The rest is up to the FORM COMPUTER. It will tell you exactly how many stitches to cast on and how many rows to knit, when and how many stitches to increase or decrease.

The FORM COMPUTER also solves the problem of differing results when comparing the measurements of test squares in our descriptions and the ones obtained by you. Hunting for the stated yarn is also a thing of the past, as again the FORM COMPUTER is here to deal with this problem.

In addition we can now offer you more sizes than so far. Every programme has been worked out to cover three sizes, and as they can be further adapted to your own measurements, this will amount to at least six sizes.

Why not convince yourself of the advantages of the FORM COMPUTER when you next visit your stockist?

Please note the new abbreviations for the pattern descriptions

2 R	Knit 2 rows
4 R	Knit 4 rows
1 	Racking handle one full turn to the right
2 	Racking handle two full turns to the right
1 	Racking handle one full turn to the left
	Transfer stitches from back to front
	Transfer stitches from front to back

Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i. e. first knit one part according to diagram (increasing or decreasing at right), then the second part the opposite way (decreasing or increasing at left).

Abbreviations:

○	= tubular (or) = half tubular	+	= increase
●	= every (in every row)	-	= decrease, cast off
X	= times	▲	= graduations (short rows)

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

First increase or decrease always occurs in the first row of a section.

+ 3 × 2 · 8 · R	means: increase 2 stitches 3 times in every 8th row (1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front).
- 19 × 3 · 7 · R	means: decrease 3 stitches 19 times in every 7th row (back 2 stitches, front 1 stitch or vice versa).
- 17 × 1 · 2 / 3 · R	means: decrease 1 stitch 17 times, alternately once after 2 rows and once after 3 rows.
▲ - 4 × 8 · 2 · R	means: work graduations, i. e. short rows (on DUO with pushers and lock BX). Step by step put 8 nds (and their respective pushers) into Rest Position 4 times after every 2nd row (for double bed 4 nds each back and front). Once all graduations are finished, continue knitting normally, i. e. all nds in Working Position (pushers in Neutral Position).

Graduations can be knitted two ways, either from outer edge towards centre (gradual decreasing with the minus-sign "-" after the black triangle) or from the centre towards outer edge (gradual increasing with the plus-sign "+" after the black triangle.)

Number of stitches and centimetres :

136 = 20 cm	means: a total of 136 sts (for K/K 68 stitches each on back and front) make a width of 20 cm.
○ 146 = 43 cm	means: cast on 146 sts each on back and front bed for tubular which makes a width of 43 cm.

Stitch size: These indications are only recommended by us. They must always be tested by you, by making your own test square for your own wool.

Knitting with the FORM COMPUTER

Very often you will be confronted with the instruction "Use programme for neckband knitted straight" when you come to knit neck or armhole bands, or even bands for the front opening of a jacket. The programme referred to is the following :

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always the same measurement must be entered.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

When knitting a neck or armhole band, therefore, measure the opening of the neck or armhole after all the parts have been knitted, and enter the measurement obtained in the space saying "neck opening". When measuring the neck opening be on the mean side, in other words measure rather less than too much, and then ease in any fullness of the neck edge into the band when you attach it. (Most neck edges are cast off rather loosely and tend to stretch). However, beware of making the neck so tight that it won't go over your head any more. For polo necks which should fit closely, you have to pull your test square sideways when measuring it.

Front bands for jacket.

Sideways knitted band : Measure the edge of the jacket and enter the result in the space for width of band. For the height enter about 3 to 4 cms (In the following garment descriptions the height of the band is always given).

Band knitted lengthways : Here you enter about 3 to 4 cms for the width of the band and for the height you enter the measurement of the jacket front edge, or if you wish to knit the band all in one piece, the measurements of both front edges plus neck edge. (Note : The FORM COMPUTER cannot exceed 1000 rows).

To make up : Block and press part lightly. Join side seam, i.e. unravel contrast yarn and graft together st by st. Attach border along the top edge. Sew straps in position.

Skirt

Fig. VII + VIII : Knitted in one piece. Begin and end with contrast yarn. A = single-bed cast on over the whole width of the needle bed (179 sts). In addition, bring 5 nds in to W.P. at right edge on back bed. Knit acc. to diagram 1, at the same time begin with the graduations (short rows) at left edge, St.S at back 3/4, front 5. B = inc. by making graduations. C = knit straight. Knit sections A, B and C 11 times in all.

Waistband : Begin and end with contrast yarn. Green, with 7 sts on back bed and 8 sts on front bed, lock CX/CX, St.S 4 1/2, knit tubular band measuring 76 cm.

To make up : Block and press part lightly. Graft together side seam, st by st, unravelling contrast yarn. Insert waist elastic into waistband and join into a ring. Attach waistband to skirt, gathering top of skirt.

Jacket

Fig. I :

A = tubular cast on in 1:1 rib with 150 sts. Immediately after casting on transfer all sts to front bed for st.st. St.S 5, alternately knit 2 rows green, 2 rows white. Straight at each end. B = inc. at each end. C = dec. at each end acc. to diagram. D = divide work. Cast off centre 26 sts. Place left half onto deckercomb. Right half : shape neck at left, shape shoulder at right. Left half : return sts to nds of machine and knit section D with reversed shapings.

Fig. IIa : left front part

A = tubular cast on in 1:1 rib with 75 sts. Immediately after casting on, transfer sts to back bed, put 17 nds and corresponding pushers in W.P. at left front. Knit in pattern acc. to diagram 2 using the U80. Position card reader in such a way that the perforated pattern hangs exactly underneath the 17 pushers brought into W.P. B = inc. at right, knit straight at left. C = dec. at right, at the same time shape neck at left. D = shape shoulder at right, cont. to dec. at left.

Fig. IIb : right front part

Only the stitches of one bed are indicated in the diagram.

A = tubular cast on in K/K with 70 sts on each bed. Acc. to diagram 1, knit straight at each end. B = inc. at left, knit straight at right. C = dec. at left acc. to diagram, shape neck at right.


Edge borders : knitted lengthwise

Green, single-bed cast on with 9 sts on back bed, and additionally 4 sts at left front. Lock at back N, St.S 4 3/4, lock at front CX, St.S 3 1/4, knit binding long enough to fit round jacket and sleeve edges.

To make up : Block and press parts lightly. Join shoulder and side seams. Attach binding to jacket, outside first, then inside.







Fig. X : Yoke, knit twice. Begin and end with contrast yarn.

A = blue, single-bed cast on with 80 sts. St.S 7, knit 2 rows. B = with lock on BX without arrow key, beginning with the 40 sts at centre front, make graduations (short rows) acc. to diagram. C = with lock on N, knit 10 rows straight. D = make graduations acc. to diagram and lock BX without arrow key. E = lock N, knit 2 rows across all sts.
 To make up : Block and press parts lightly with the exception of the yoke which is left to dry under a damp cloth. Join shoulder, side and sleeve seams. Set in sleeves. Fold cuffs in half to inside and hem in position st by st, unravelling contrast yarn. Fill yoke with acrylic padding material and graft together (st by st) the open ends. Sew yoke to main part of dress as shown in photo.

 A = brown, tubular cast on for 2:2 rib acc. to diagram over a width of 179 nds. St.S 5/4, knit 10 rows. B = transfer all sts to front, occasionally placing 2 sts onto 1 nd, so that every alternate nd is out of W.P. = 90 sts. Knit straight. C = cont. to knit straight. D = divide work. Cast off centre 12 sts. Place left half onto dekercomb. Right half : shape neck at left, shape shoulder at right. Left half : replace sts onto nds of machine and knit section D with reversed shapings.

Fig. II :
 A = as for Fig. I. B = transfer all sts to front. Knit 30 rows. Knit intarsia as follows : thread green into right feeding eyelet, brown into left feeding eyelet. When you knit, always place the yarn into the next non-working needle on the side where the lock is. After every section of the intarsia, return the row counter to zero. Knit the sections of the intarsia in the numbered sequence (1 = brown, dec. at left. 2 = green, inc. at right, after 16 rows dec. at the same time at left. 3 = brown, inc. at right, etc.). C = green, lock on N. Divide work. Cast off centre 12 sts. Place left half onto dekercomb. Right half : shape neck at left, knit straight at right. D = cont. to dec. at left, shape shoulder at right. Neckband :
 Brown, tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 154 sts over a width of 116 nds. St.S 6, knit 6 rows. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.
To make up : Block and press parts well. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Join side and sleeve seams. Attach neckband to outside neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn.



To make up : Block and press all parts.

Pink sweater (a) : Join shoulder seams. Matching dots and arrows acc. to diagram, set in sleeves, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Join side and sleeve seams. Sew neckband to outside neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn.

Blue sweater (b) : As given for pink sweater; mitre V-neck band at centre front using mattress stitch.







Diagram for fairisle





Using contrast yarn, make single-bed cast on on back bed. Bring nds of front bed into Working Position, for summer fairisle. Knit acc. to diagram and colour sequence. End with a few rows contrast yarn on back bed, release sts of both beds.

Fig. IIIb : cuff, knit two

Tubular cast on in aubergine. Cont. to knit in pin tuck pattern acc. to diagram, at the same time inc. at each end. Cast off.

Front neckband :

With 75 sts single-bed cast on for st.st., aubergine, knit 20 rows in st.st. Bring 75 nds on opposite bed into W.P. Knit 1 row with lock N/N, then 6 rows at back in st.st. with lock back N, front GX. Knit 6 rows at front in st.st. with lock at front N, at back GX. End with a few rows contrast yarn with lock N/N.

To make up : Press contrast yarn on neck edge and sleeve edge. Block the other parts and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Join shoulders, and at the place where the pattern ends let the rows knitted in st.st. roll to the front or to the back. Sew neckband first to the outside neck edge, then to inside, st by st, backstitching into the open loops, unravel contrast yarn. Sew the st.st. rows invisibly with mattress stitch to the st.st. rows of the shoulders. At top edge of sleeve, make a pleat approx. 10 cm wide and then join the sleeve to back and front part. Gather sleeve at wrist and with right sides facing sew to cuff. Join side and sleeve seams.

Sew trimmings, first on the outside, then on the inside, to armhole and hem, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Join skirt and bodice. Sew waist band in position on top of waist seam, at the same time unravel contrast yarn. Insert band.



Straps : knit twice

Cast on with 7 sts on front bed and 6 sts on back bed, white. St.S 3 1/2 at back, front 2 3/4, lock N/CX, knit 300 rows.

To make up : Block and press parts lightly. Jacket : Join side and sleeve seams. Join sleeves (with backstitch) to front and back part, unravelling contrast yarn. Join sleeve seam, then along the centre line at lower edge insert a length of shirring elastic along approx. 10 cm and gather slightly. Press bands and attach (with backstitch) to edge, unravelling contrast yarn. On the inside attach st by st. Top : Join side seams. Press bands and straps. Backstitch bands to main part, unravelling contrast yarn. Then attach to inside. Sew straps in position.

Flashing figures :

- 1 Tubular cast on in 1:1 rib
- 2 Transfer all sts to front bed, cont. to knit stocking stitch
- 5 Cast off all remaining sts
