with 8 corresponding additional pages in the Description Book with FORM COMPUTER programmes! All because we would like to offer you an even larger and more interesting selection of garments. More than 90% of the garments have their own FORM COMPUTER programmes in at least three different sizes, and sometimes up to five sizes. As, in most cases, the programme can be enlarged by one standard size, this means in effect, a choice of between 6 to 10 sizes.

These extra pages have given us the opportunity to meet an often expressed wish by our customers for more childrens wear, particularly small children, and on the other hand for larger sizes. As you will see there are FORM COMPUTER programmes up to size 50 for some of the classic designs.

We have also taken the opportunity to introduce yet another young American artist, Susan Summa, who produces "Wearable Art" on our handknitting machines. A very fine example of the unlimited creative possibilities our knitting machines offer, and also an encouragement to other knitters to use their own, maybe as yet undiscovered, creative talents.

Please note the new abbreviations for the pattern descriptions

- 2 R Knit 2 rows
- 4 R Knit 4 rows
- 1  Racking handle one full turn to the right
- 2  Racking handle two full turns to the right
- 1  Racking handle one full turn to the left
-  Transfer stitches from back to front
-  Transfer stitches from front to back

Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i.e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i.e. first knit one part according to diagram (increasing or decreasing at right), then the second part the opposite way (decreasing or increasing at left).

Abbreviations:

- ▣ tubular (or) ▣ half tubular + = increase
- ▣ every (in every row) - = decrease, cast off
- X ▣ times ▲ = graduations (short rows)

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i.e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Knitting with the FORM COMPUTER

Very often you will be confronted with the instruction "Use programme for neckband knitted straight" when you come to knit neck or armhole bands, or even bands for the front opening of a jacket. The programme referred to is the following :

RZ = RC

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always the same measurement must be entered.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

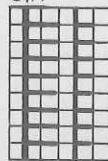
Skirt in the ethnic-tradition look

Size : hips 88 cm to 100 cm
Material : 180 g fine mohair : 165 g green, 15 g cream
Stitch size : 5/2
Test square : 100 sts = 38 cm, 100 R = 22 cm
Pattern : Skirt knitted sideways in one piece. Single-bed fairisle pattern with DECO punchcard 89, single motif for trimming. Knit waistband separately to be sewn or crocheted on.

1000 m length per 100 g
 314 yds per 1 cm
 10 cm = approx. 4"

Fig. VII + VIII : Knit in one piece. Begin and end with contrast yarn.
A = single-bed cast on over the whole front bed width. Position card reader and single motif in such a way that the pattern begins 16 sts in from right edge (over 17 sts). Knit RC 1280 in single-bed fairisle acc. to diagram. Note : Be sure to set the yarn tension for the cream colour absolutely correctly, this will prevent loops forming.
Waistband : Begin and end with contrast yarn.
 Green, tubular cast on with 9 sts on each bed. St.S 5 1/2, knit RC 650 tubular.
To make up : Block and press parts carefully. Graft side seam, unravel contrast yarn. Insert waist elastic into waistband, join into a ring and attach to skirt top, gathering skirt slightly.

 empty square = basic colour, green

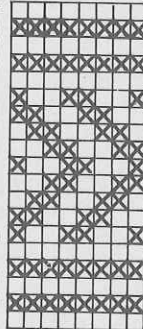
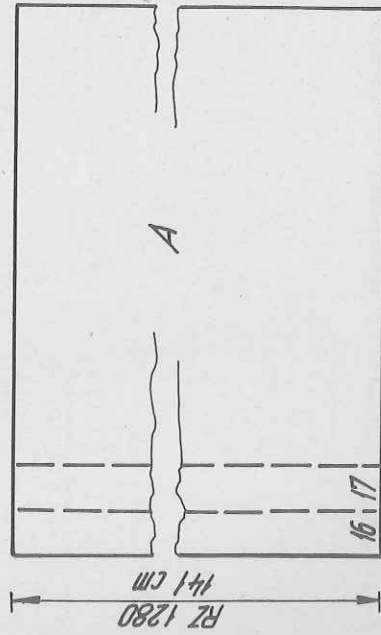

Buttonhole band : Begin and end with contrast yarn.
 Green, tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 236 sts over 176 nds. St.S 3, knit 7 rows, then arrange buttonholes as follows : counting from right edge, knit with contrast yarn over the second of the groups of two sts on front bed plus 1 st either side on back bed (i.e. over a total of 4 sts), leave the sts on the nds. On front bed count 5 groups of 2 sts, then over the 6th group plus 1 st either side on back bed knit with contrast yarn. Repeat, knit 4 buttonholes altogether. Knit 16 rows, then repeat the buttonhole row as given above. Knit 7 more rows.
Buttonband : Begin and end with contrast yarn.
 Green, tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 236 sts over 176 nds. St.S 3, knit 30 rows.

Neckband on back part :
 Knit as given for buttonband, but with 60 sts over 44 nds.

Armhole band : Begin and end with contrast yarn.
Single-bed cast on with 7 sts on front bed, St.S 5 1/2, knit 246 rows, alternately 2 rows green, 2 rows cream, at the same time dec. 1 st at right ev. 4 rows & inc. 1 st at left.
Pocket :

Lightly press the place of the pocket opening and unravel contrast yarn. Place the 27 sts of the lower edge onto nds of machine, arranged for 2:2 rib, and with St.S 3 knit 20 rows in main yarn, end with a few rows of contrast yarn, release. Now place the 27 sts of upper edge onto nds of machine, and with St.S 5 1/2 knit 40 rows in st.st. End with contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Block and press parts carefully. Join shoulder and side seams. Fold 2:2 rib cast on in half to inside and catch down. Sew front bands to their respective edges first to outside, then to inside, unravel contrast yarn. Attach back neckband in the same way. Unravel contrast yarn on buttonholes and neaten. Attach buttons to correspond. Sew armhole bands in position with invisible sts, first to outside then to inside.
Pocket : Fold 2:2 rib band in half to inside and attach st by st, unravel contrast yarn. Place the two front parts flat on the table, then sew the inside pocket parts in position.

FORM COMPUTER

If you want to knit this skirt with the Form Computer, use the programme for "neckband knitted straight" on page 2 of this description book. At "cm width of band" insert the desired length of the skirt (e.g. 68 cm). At "cm height of band" insert the desired width of the skirt. The Form Computer will not give you any indications on where to position the trimmings.

Lady's fairisle sweater

- Size : to fit 88 cm bust
- Material : 540 g medium acrylic/mohair : 290 g dark green, 100 g pale green, 100 g aubergine, 50 g black.
- Stitch size : Fairisle = 4 1/2, 2:2 rib = 4
- Test square : 100 sts = 17 cm, 100 R = 10,5 cm
- Pattern : Fairisle with self-punched DECO card.

Fig. I : back

A = black, tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 184 sts over a width of 138 nds.
 B = bring all nds into Working Position. Dark green, knit 2 rows with lock front and back CX, then knit in fairisle acc. to diagram. At RC 184 begin fairisle pattern in aubergine using deco card. C = shape armhole at each end, main colour now pale green. D = shape shoulder at each end, cast off.

Fig. II : front

A + B = as for Fig. I. C = shape armhole at each end, main colour pale green. D = divide work. Place left half onto dekercombs. Right half : knit straight at right, shape neck at left. E = shape shoulder at right. Left half : place sts back onto nds of machine and knit sections D + E with reversed shapings.

Fig. III : sleeves

A = black, tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 83 sts over a width of 62 nds.
 B = bring all nds into Working Position, dark green, knit 2 rows with lock front and back CX, then fairisle acc. to diagram. At RC 252 begin with fairisle pattern in aubergine using DECO card. C = main colour now pale green, shape sleeve head at each end. Cast off remaining sts.

Fig. III : knit two

A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = take pushers out of blocking rail and arrange acc. to diagram. Inc. at each end as per diagram. C = shape sleeve head at each end. Cast off remaining sts.

Collar :

Tubular, closed cast on, St.S 5 1/2, lock back and front CX, 110 nds.
 Knit until RC 76. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

Front band :

Tubular, closed cast on with 46 nds, Knit until RC 24. Now work 3 button-holes as follows : knit 4 sts, knit the following 3 back sts and the 4 front sts with contrast yarn, knit 12 sts in the normal way, the following 3 back and 4 front sts with contrast yarn, repeat. 6 sts remain at the end of the row. Knit RC 24. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release. Knit a second band but omit buttonholes.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join side and shoulder seams. Join sleeve seams. Set in sleeves. With backstitch sew front band without buttonholes to front opening, unravelling contrast yarn. Unravel contrast yarn on buttonholes and neaten, then attach band to front opening, unravelling contrast yarn. Sew lower edge of bands to main part with invisible sts. Backstitch collar to neck opening, unravel contrast yarn. Attach buttons.

Neckband : Tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 128 sts over a width of 96 nds.

Knit RC 40, transfer all sts to front bed, knit 2 rows st.st. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join shoulder seam. St by st, backstitch neckband to outside neck edge, unravelling contrast yarn. Then to inside.

Join ends. Join sleeve and side seams. With right sides facing, set in sleeves

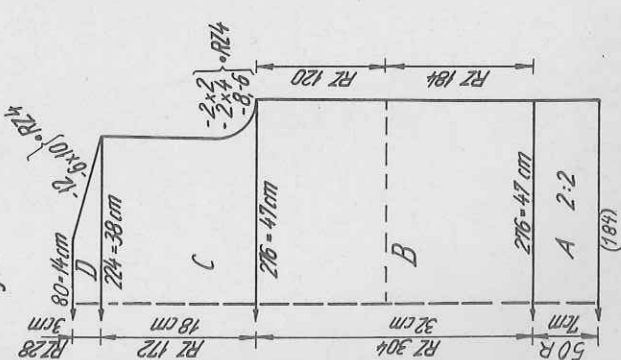

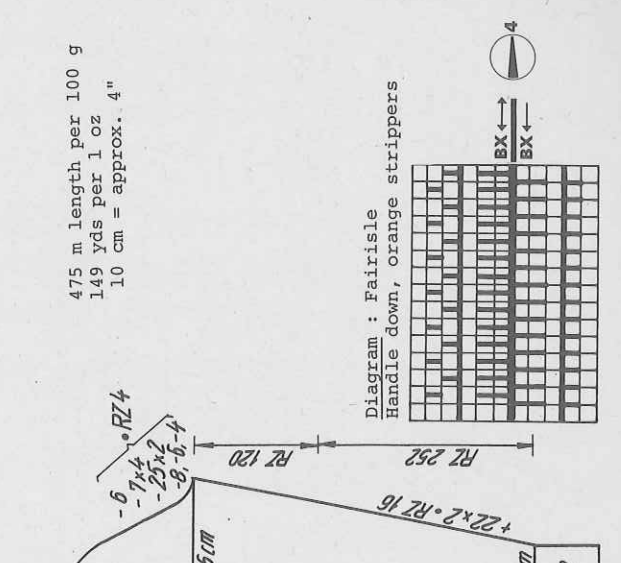
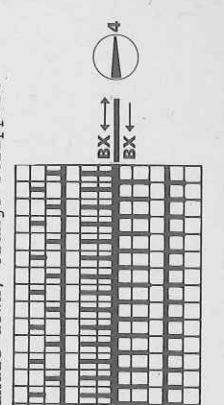


Diagram : Fairisle

Baby's rompers and sweater

- Size :** height 86 cm (1 year old)
Material : Rompers : 180 g medium cotton, mercerized : 160 g yellow, 20 g rust
 Sweater : 120 g cotton : 100 g rust, 20 g yellow.
 2 buttons, 2 press studs.
Stitch size : Stocking stitch = 5/2, 1:1 rib = 3
Test square : Double-bed fairisle for bib = front and back 3
 St.st. : 100 sts = 29 cm, 100 R = 21 cm
 Fairisle : 100 sts = 30 cm, 100 R = 21 cm
Pattern : All parts stocking stitch. Bib = double-bed fairisle with DECO-card to be punched acc. to motif chart.

Sweater

Fig. I : back
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, yellow. B = transfer all sts to front for st.st. Cont. in rust. C = transfer sts for 1:1 rib, cont. in yellow. Cast off all sts.
Fig. II : front
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, yellow. B = transfer all sts for st.st. to front bed. Cont. in rust. C = divide work, cast off centre sts. Place left half onto deckercombs. Right half : shape neck at left, knit straight at right. D = transfer sts for 1:1 rib, cont. in yellow. Cast off sts.
 Knit left half with reversed shapings.

Fig. III : sleeve
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = transfer all sts to front for st.st. Cont. in rust. Inc. at each end. Cast off.

Neckband : Yellow, tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with 68 nds, St.S 3, knit 10 rows. Transfer all sts to front for st.st., knit 1 row with St.S 4. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join side and sleeve seams. Place shoulder bands one over the other (front shoulder onto back shoulder). Set in sleeves. Press neckband, attach to neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops. Sew on two press studs on each side.

Fig. IX : rompers, begin and end with contrast yarn
 A = yellow, st.st., knit straight at right. B = inc. at each end. C = straight. D = reduce number of sts by half as follows : a few rows contrast yarn, release sts. Place knitting back onto nds of machine, nds arranged for 1:1 rib, always placing 2 sts on 1 nd. Finish in rust.

To make up : Block and press parts. Join leg and crotch seams. Fold leg bands in half, unravel contrast yarn and sew in position st by st. Place the two front parts back onto nds of machine (1 st on front bed, 1 st on back bed), unravelling contrast yarn. With rust, lock GX/N, St.S 4 1/2, knit 6 rows. Lock N/GX, knit 6 rows.

Fig. XVII : Bib : Take pushers out of blocking rail (front and back bed), arrange as per diagram. Knit in col sequence : 2 R yellow, 2 R rust to RC 12. Now starting with DECO card at 0, dec. at each end, cast off. For eyelet holes: place the remaining sts of the two trouser back parts onto nds of machine (always 2 sts onto 1 nd), unravelling contrast yarn. Knit 12 rows st.st. in rust, St.S 4 1/2. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release. Fold band in half, unravel contrast yarn and attach st by st. Join side seams of bands, make fine cord and insert.

Bib band : begin and end with contrast yarn
 Yellow, St.S 4 1/2, cast on 60 sts. Knit 6 rows. 1 row with St.S 6 1/2. 5 rows with St.S 4 1/2. Release sts. Press band and backstitch round bib, unravelling contrast yarn. Catch down on wrong side.
Strap : two alike
 Yellow, St.S 5 1/2, cast on 9 sts on each bed, lock CX/CX, knit RC 350. Cast off sts. Press straps and sew to bib front, cross straps at the back and fastened with press studs.

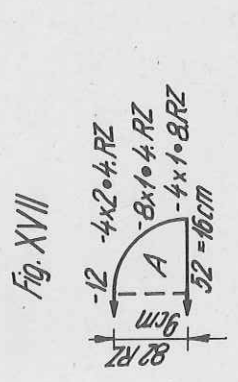
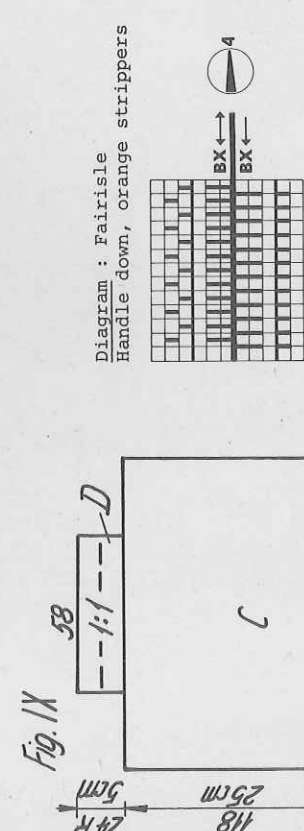
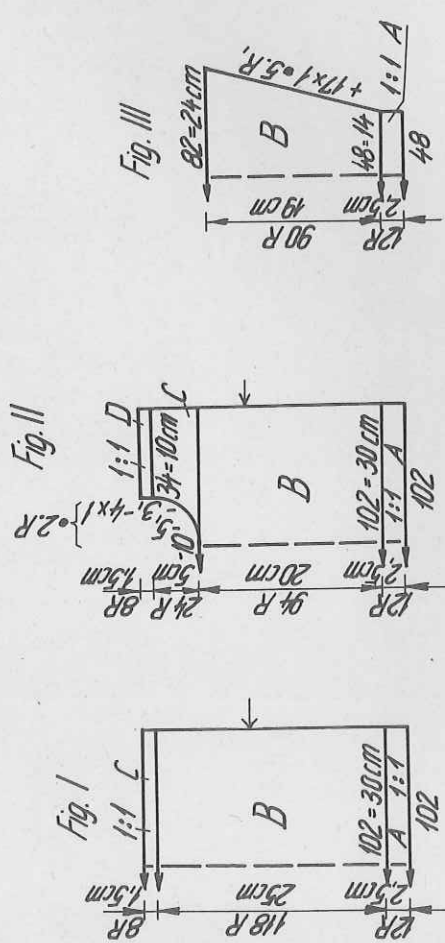


Diagram : Fairisle
 Handle down, orange strippers

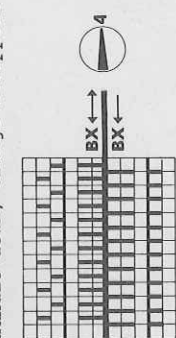

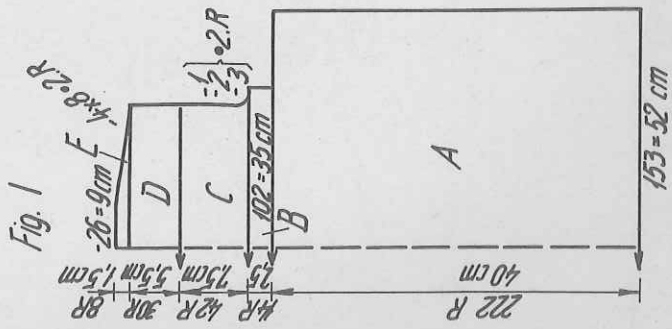

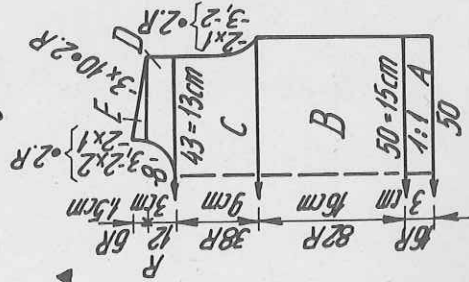


Fig. Ib ▲ 3x10, 2.R ▲

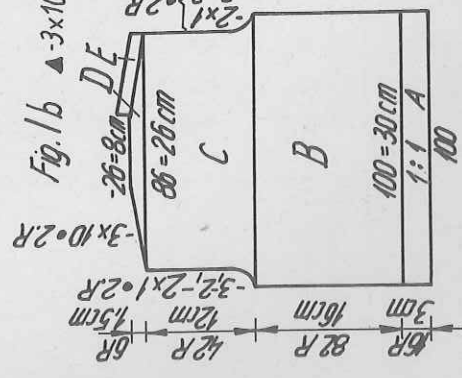

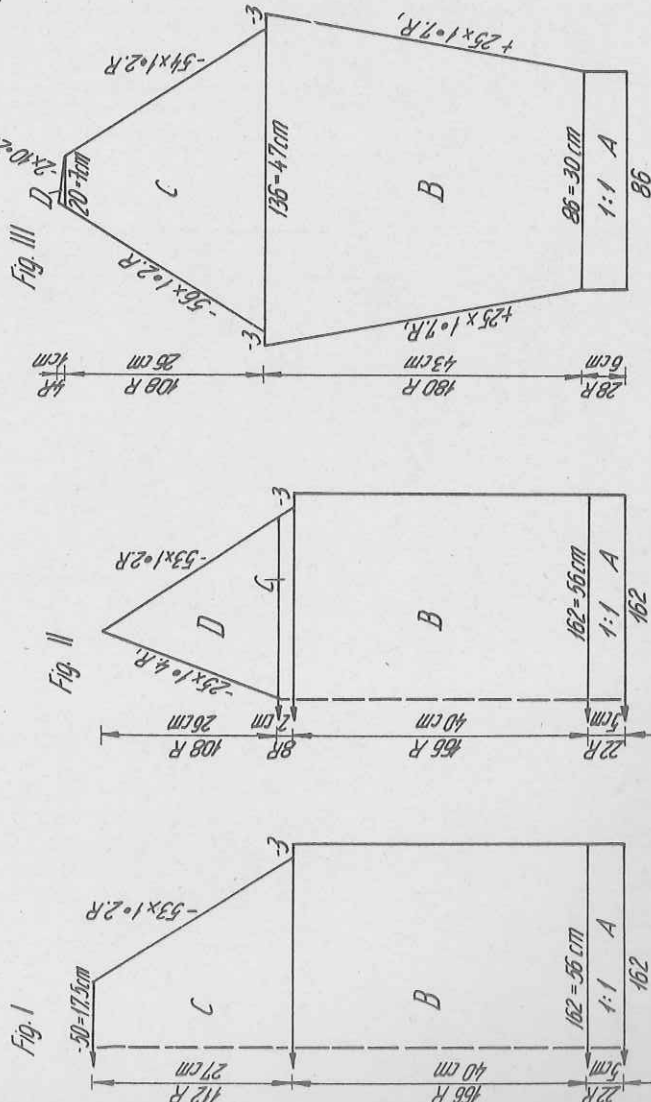

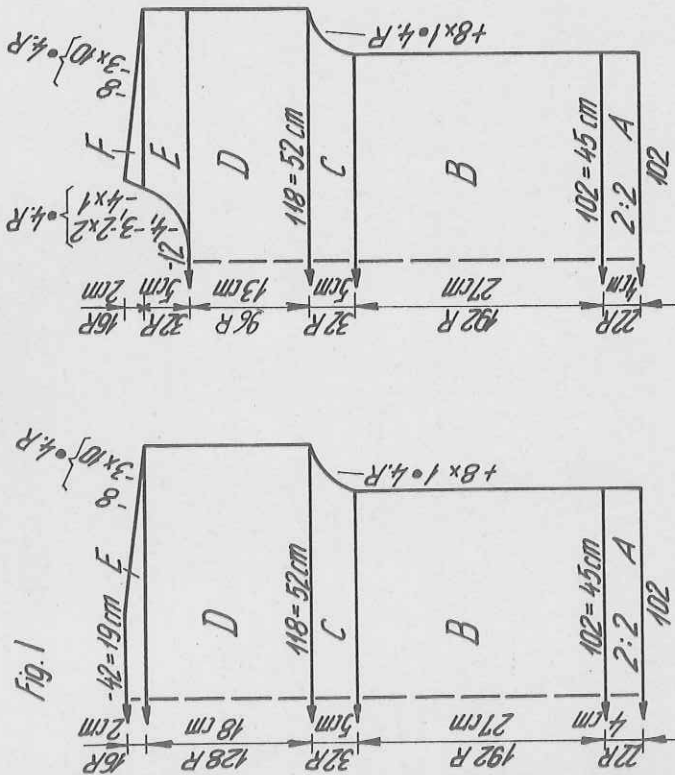

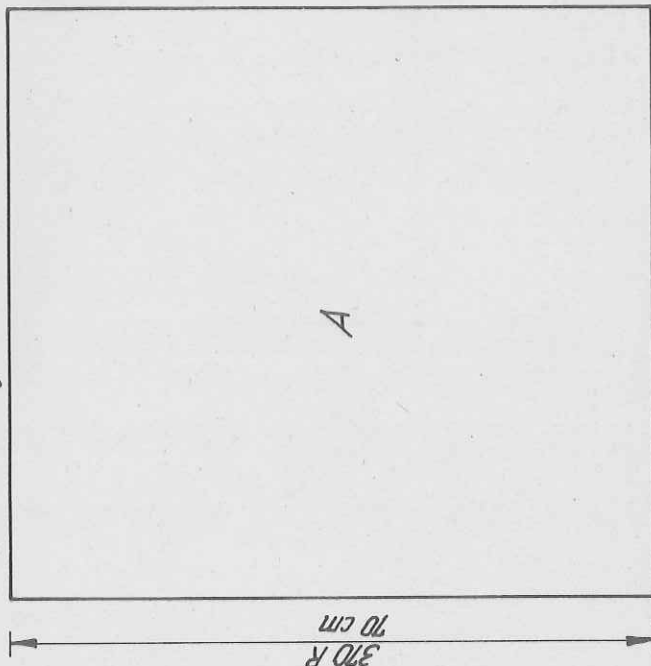
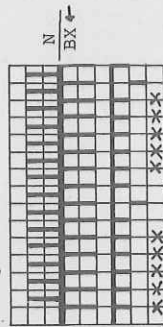


Diagram : Sweater

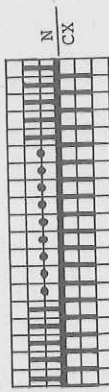
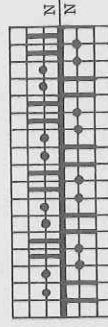


Diagram : 2:2 rib

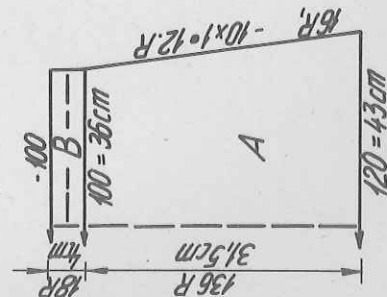

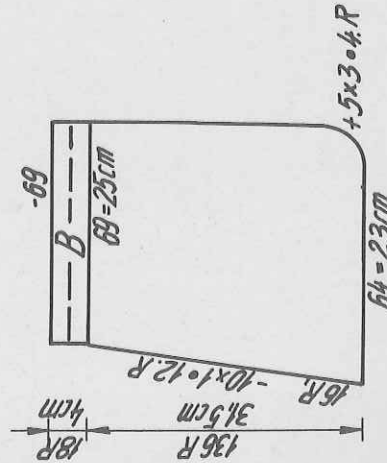

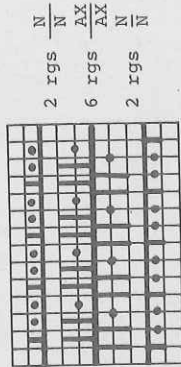

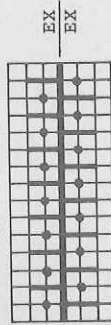

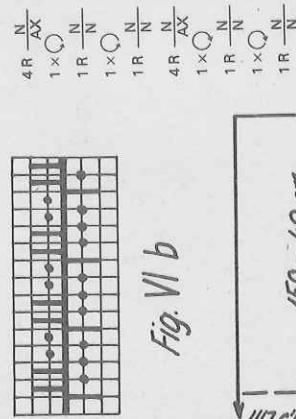

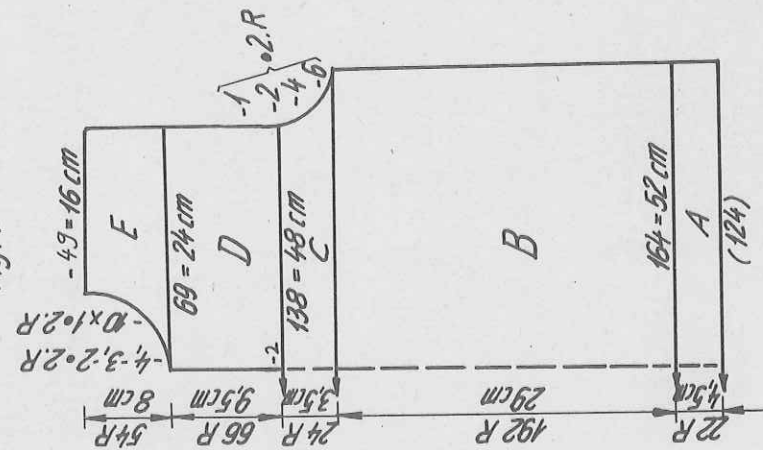

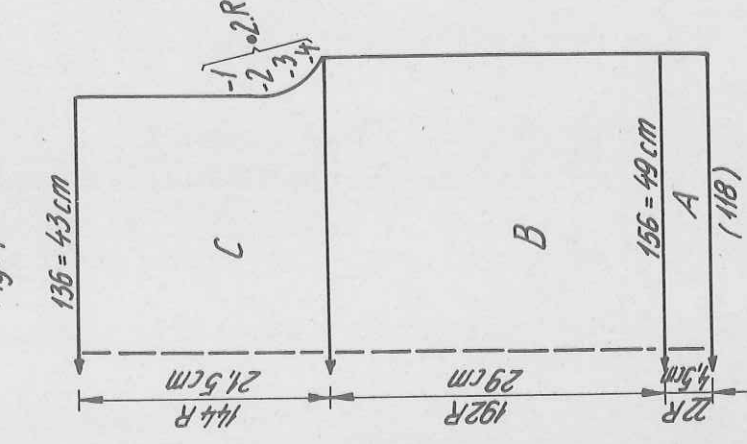

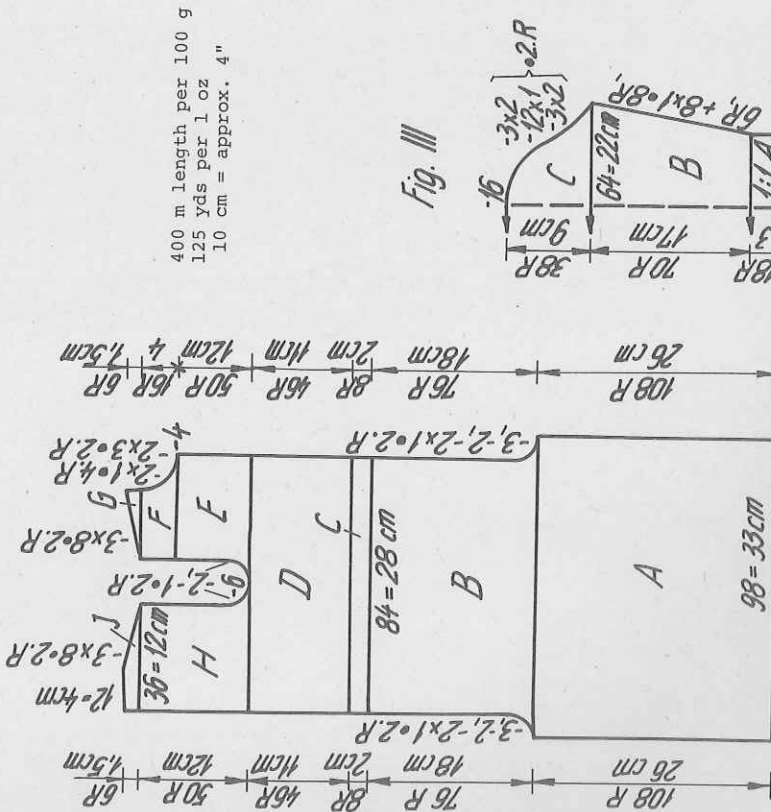

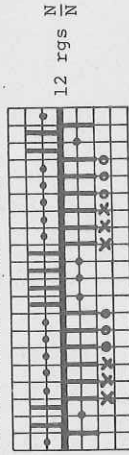

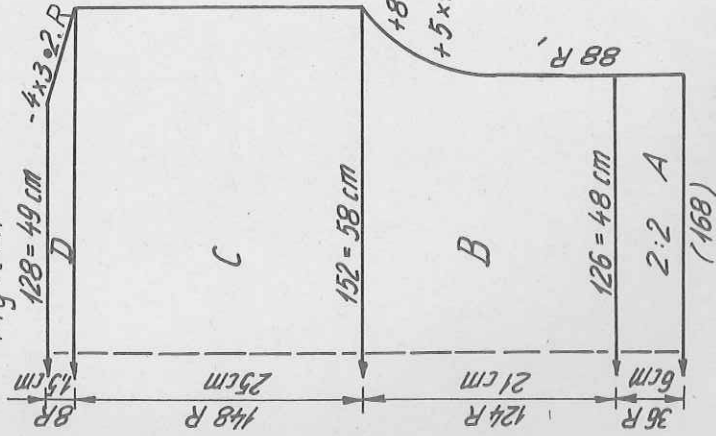
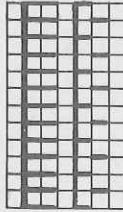


Diagram : AX-pattern

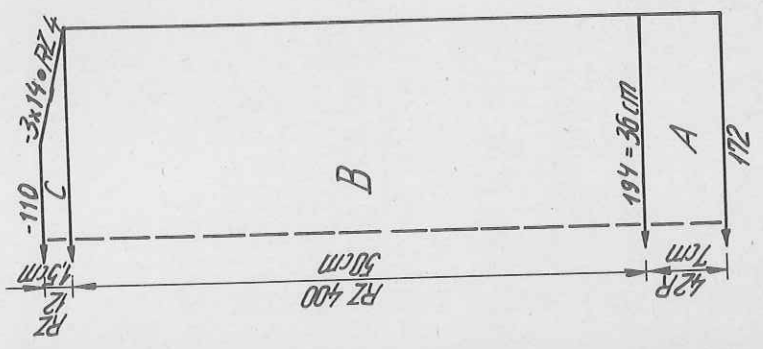

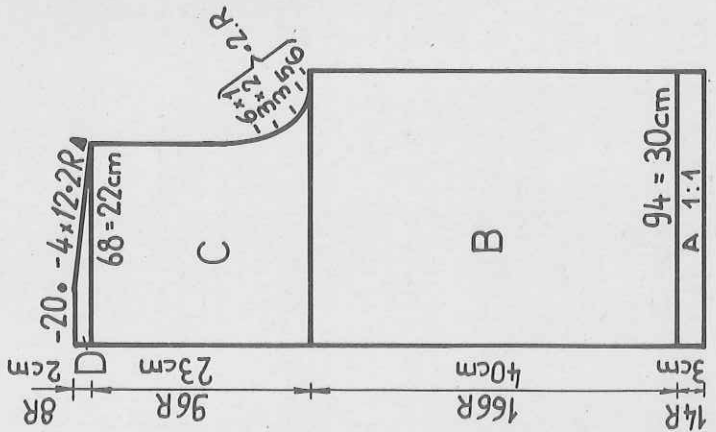

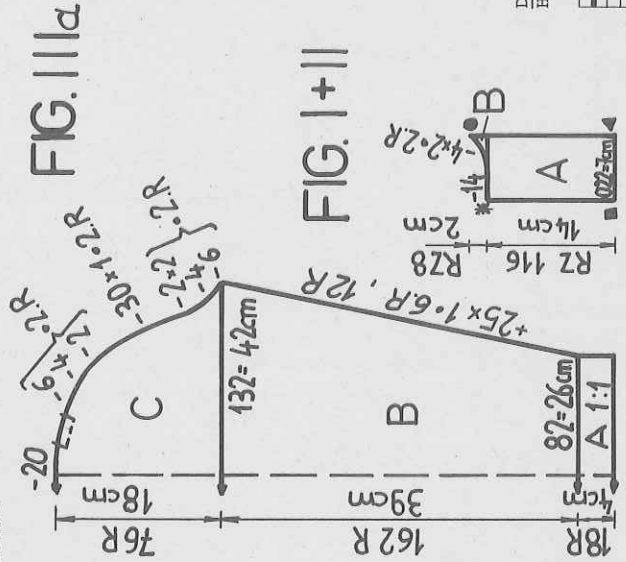

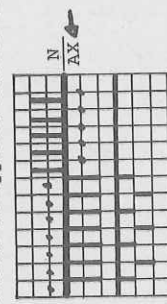
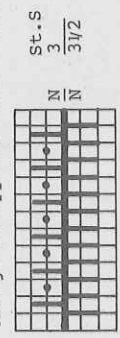


Diagram : Pattern

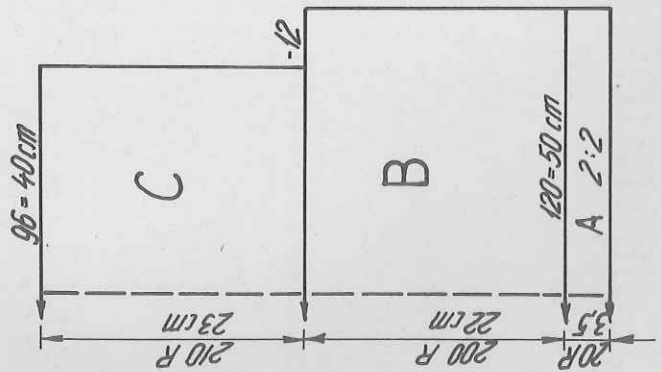

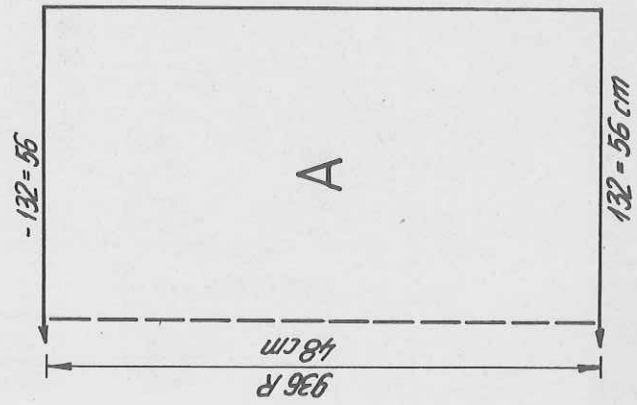
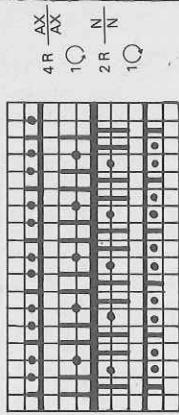


Diagram for "crochet look"

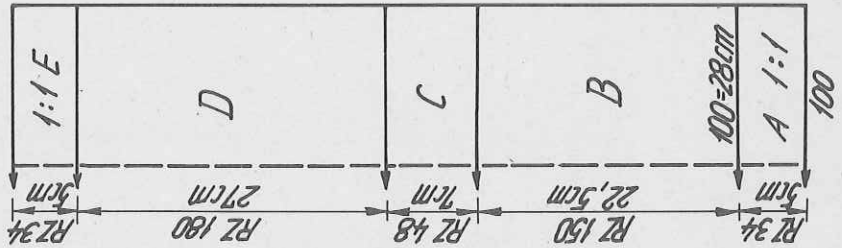

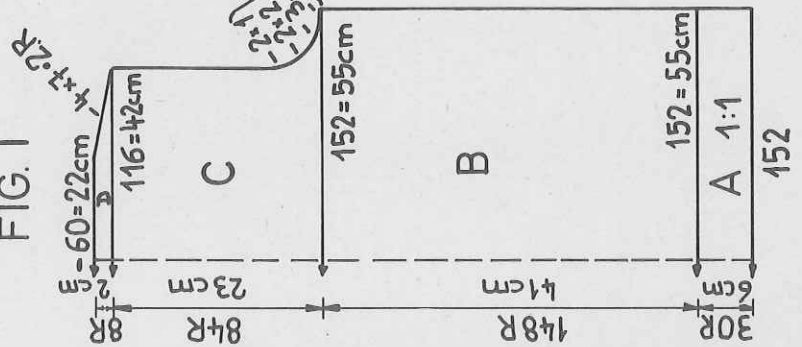

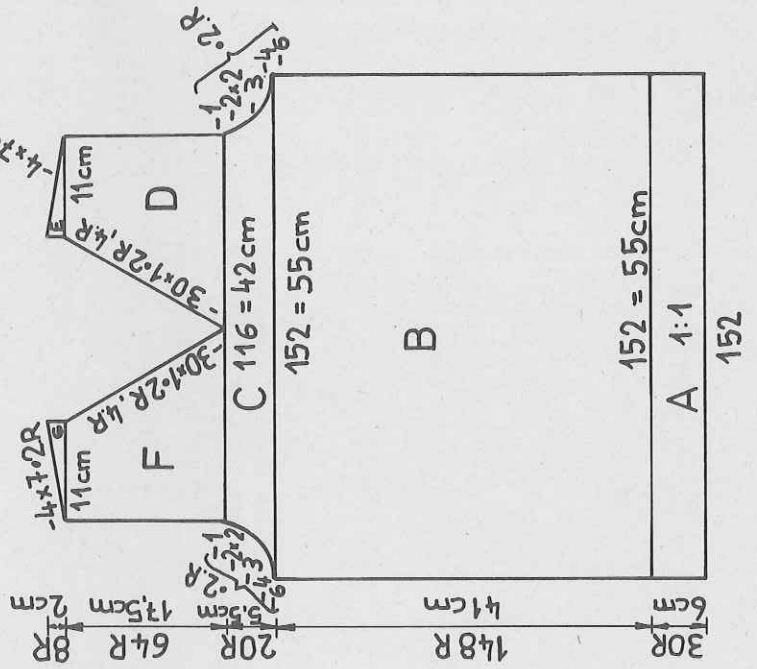

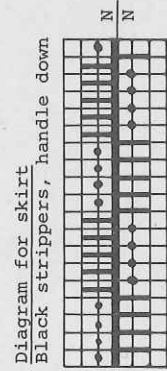
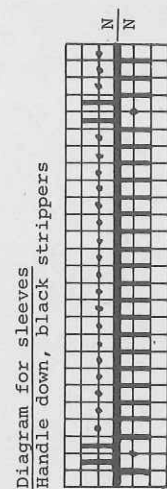


Diagram for sleeves

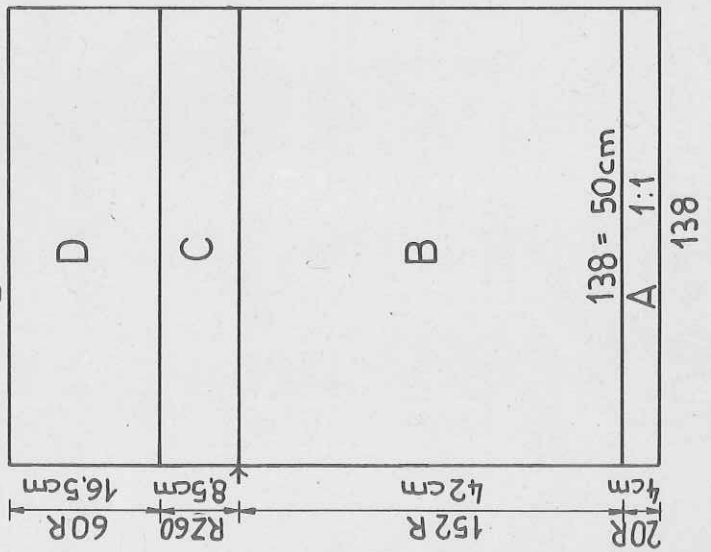

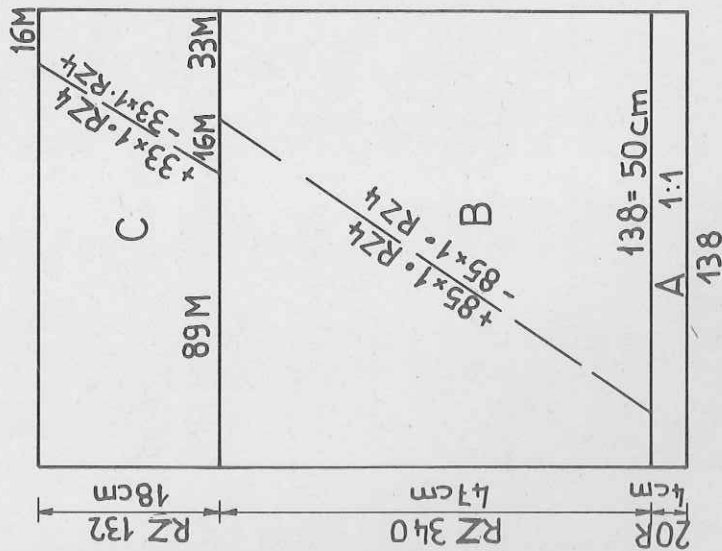

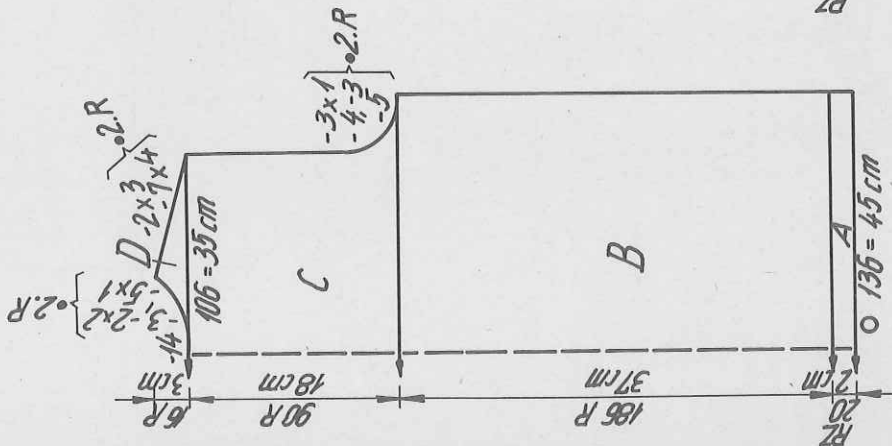

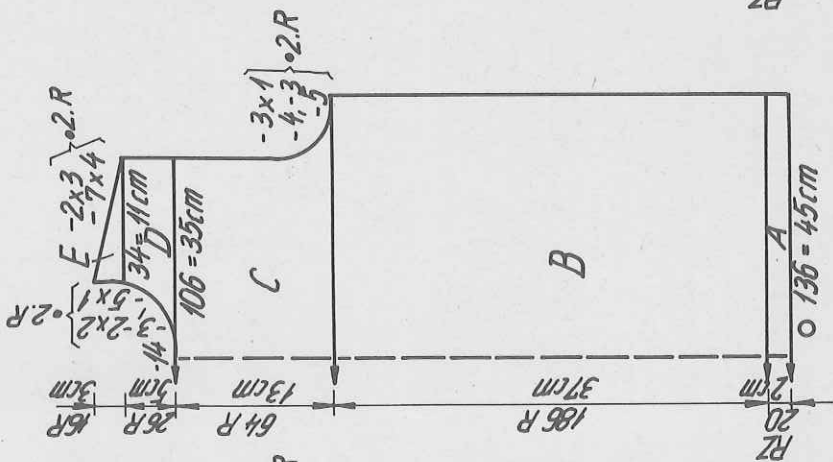

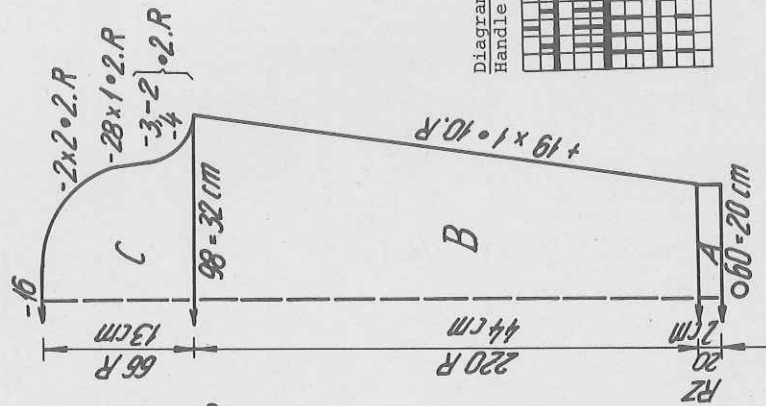
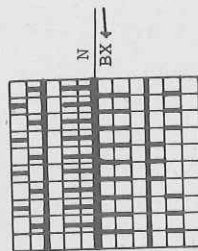


Fig. 1a : sweater back
