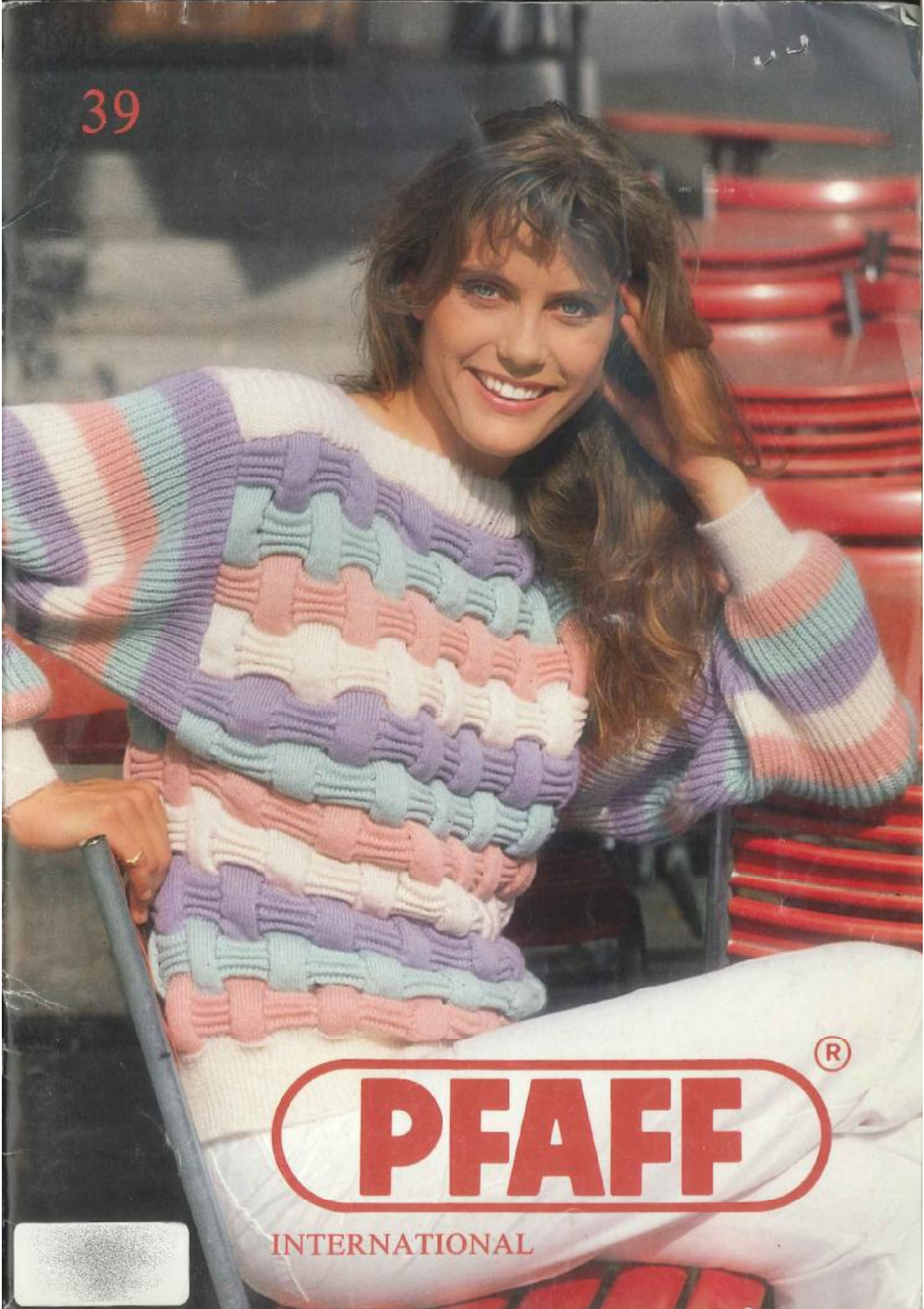


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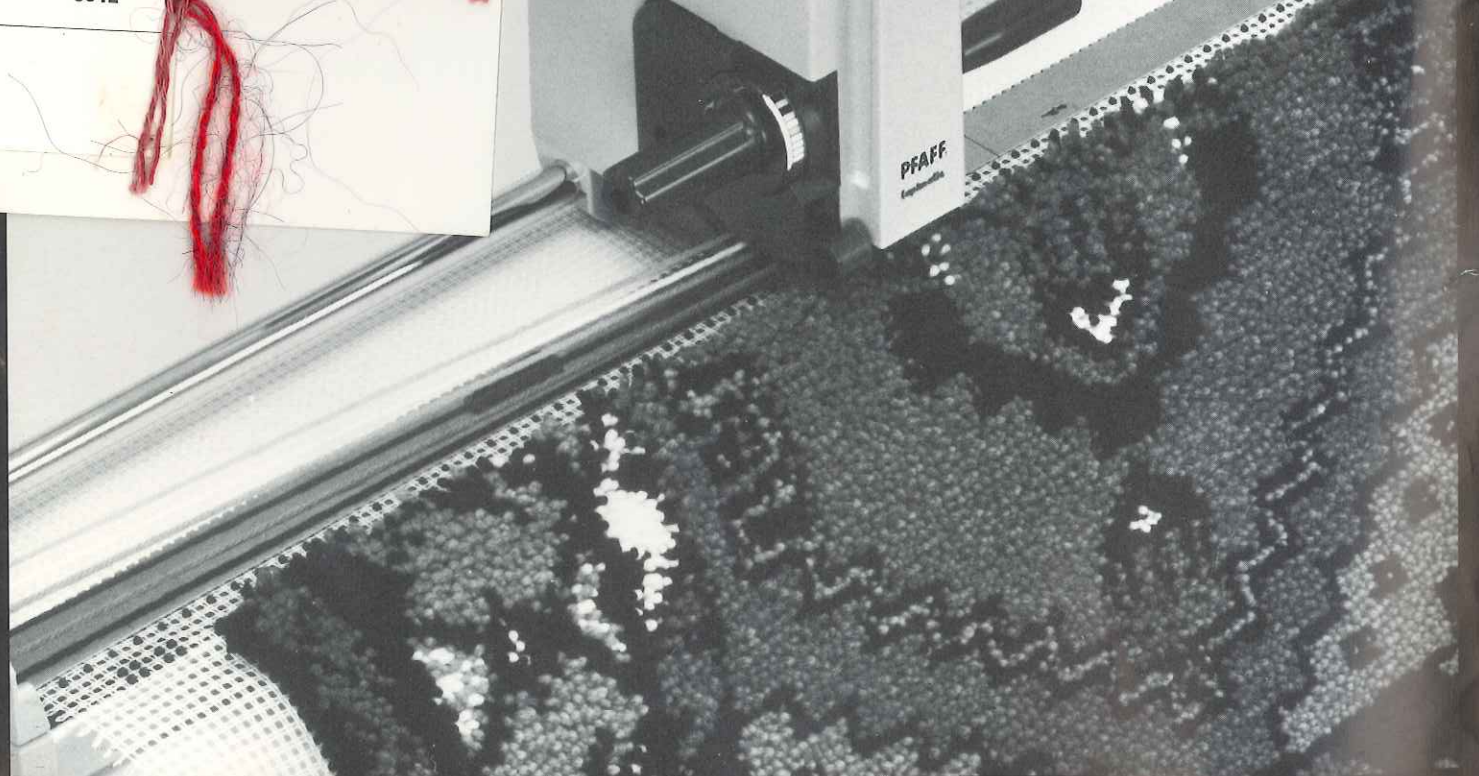
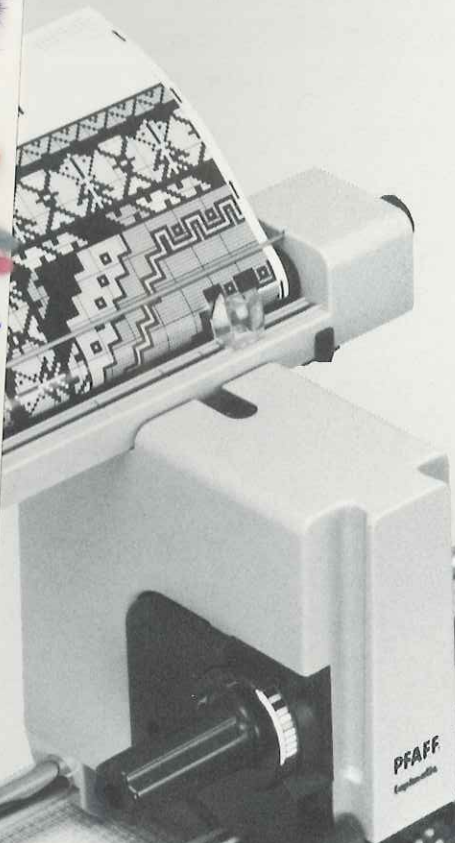

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Description Book for Model Book No. 39

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Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

IF YOU KNIT WITH THE FORM COMPUTER

Enter the measurements of your test square as follows :

- A Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of your test square
 B Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 sts of your test square
 C Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of the band. Note :
 It is possible for 'C' to appear twice in a programme, in which case the same measurement has to be entered twice.

Flashing figures :

The general meaning of the flashing figures is as follows :

- 1 Cast on over the indicated number of needles on the front bed.
- 2 Transfer from band to pattern.
- 3 Divide work into two equal halves for neck opening.
- 4 End of first shoulder, to knit second shoulder press key GO.
- 5 End of knitting.

If there is no programme for neck or armhole band, or front bands of a jacket, then use the following programme for "straight knitted band" :

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always enter the same measurement in both places.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

3901 DUOMATIC 80/S

Lady's 4-coloured sweater with U70/U80

Size : 88-92 cm bust

Material : 560 g fine acrylic/wool : 170 g beige, and 130 g of each : lilac, pink, pale green.

Stitch size : Pattern : front 4, back 5. Sleeve 4/2. Welt 2 3/4. Cuff 3/4. Neckband 4/2.

Test square : 100 sts = 35 cm (counting sts on back bed alone)
100 R = 13 cm. Sleeves and neckband : 100 sts = 44 cm
RC 100 = 14.5 cm

Pattern : Acc. to diagram. Sleeves and neckband in Fisherman's 1:1 rib. Welt in 1:1 rib. Cuffs in 1:1 rib.

Fig. I + II : Back and front. A = tub. cast on for 1:1 rib. B = transfer all sts to back bed. Arrange nds and pushers acc. to diagram and knit straight, in col. sequence : 34 R pink, 34 R pale green, 34 R lilac, 34 R beige (make sure the rows can be divided by 34). Knit 4 rows in stocking st. Cast off loosely.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two alike
A = tubular cast on for 1:1. B = cont. to knit in Fisherman's rib, inc. at each end, col. sequence following the cuff : 20 R pink, 20 R pale green, 20 R lilac, 20 R beige, repeat (make sure the rows can be divided

by 20). Cast off loosely.
Fig. V : Neckband, knit two pieces.
Tubular cast on for 1:1 with 106 sts, knit 64 rows in Fisherman's rib. Cast off loosely.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. With right sides facing, sew neckband to neck edge, stretching it slightly, sew in position on inside. Join about 14 cm on each side along shoulders with invisible stitches. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.

Note : To achieve a nice ending, make sure that the number of stitches can always be divided by 10 and that you end with a full motif in the height.

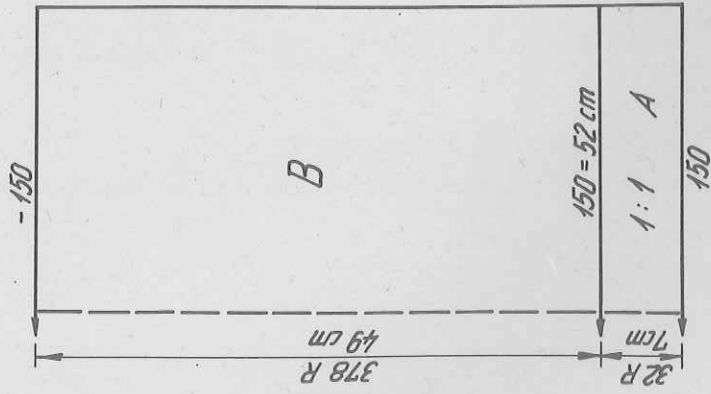

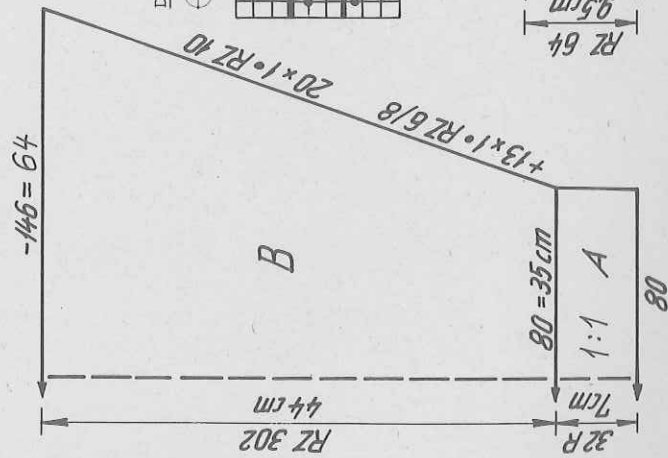


Diagram for pattern

Before you start, transfer all sts to back bed

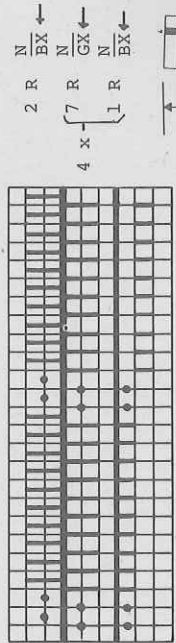
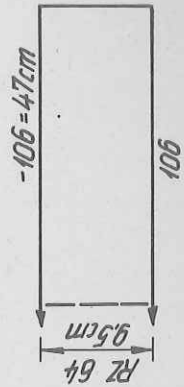

Man's sweater, pin tuck pattern with U80/U70

Size : 96-100 cm chest

Material : 630 g fine acrylic/wool

Stitch size : Pattern : front 4, back 5. Half Fisherman's rib 4.

Bands 2 3/4.

Test square : Pattern : 100 sts = 35 cm (count only sts of back bed)

100 R = 13 cm

Fish.rib (sleeves) : 100 sts = 29cm, RC 100 = 16 cm

Acc. to diagram, stripes, Half Fisherman's rib in

1:1 division. Sleeves : Half Fisherman's rib in 1:1.

Bands in 1:1 rib.

475 m length per 100 g

149 yds per 1 oz

10 cm = approx. 4"

Fig. I : Back

A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = transfer sts for pattern acc. to diagram. C = transfer sts for half fisherman's rib in 1:1. Knit D + F as given for B. E as given for C. G as for C but longer. Cast off loosely.

Fig. II : Front

A, B, C, D, E, F as for Fig. I. G as given for C, but only RC 18. H = in half fisherman's rib. Cast off centre sts. Place left half onto dekercombs. Cont. to knit right half, dec. at left for neck opening. Cast off loosely. Place sts of left half back onto nds of machine and knit with rev. shapings.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two alike

A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = cont. to knit in half fisherman's rib in 1:1 division. Inc. at each end. C = cont. straight. Cast off loosely.

Fig. V : Neckband

Tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = cont. to knit in half fisherman's rib in 1:1 division. Inc. at each end. C = cont. straight. Cast off loosely. rows contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Join shoulder seams. Join ends of neckband with mattress stitch, then, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew to outside neck edge, then to inside. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.

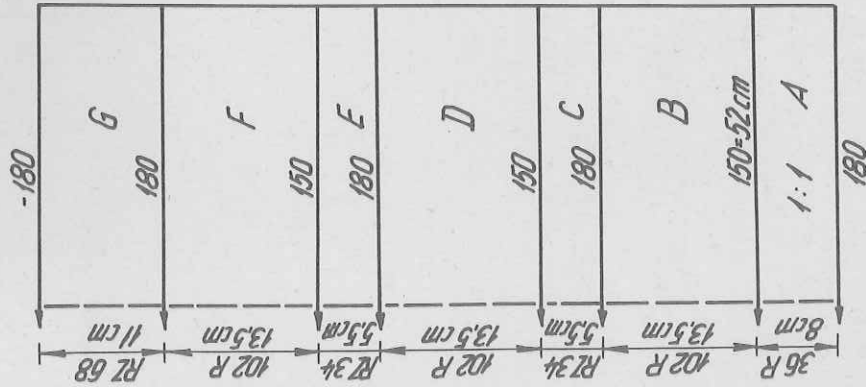

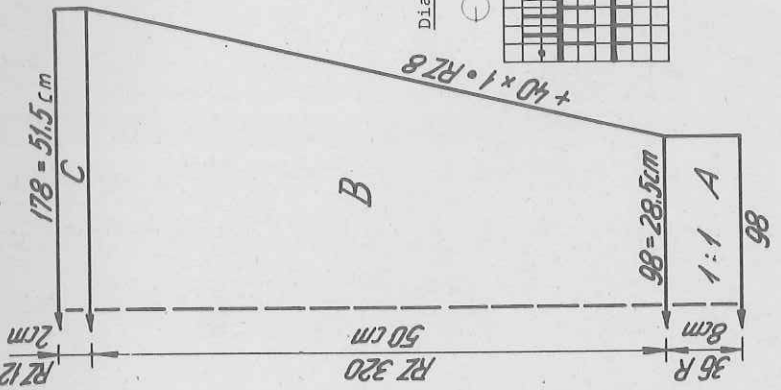
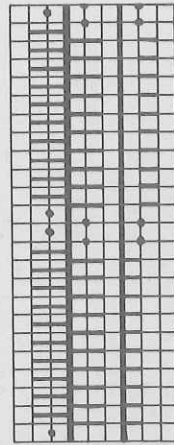


Diagram for pattern with U80/U70

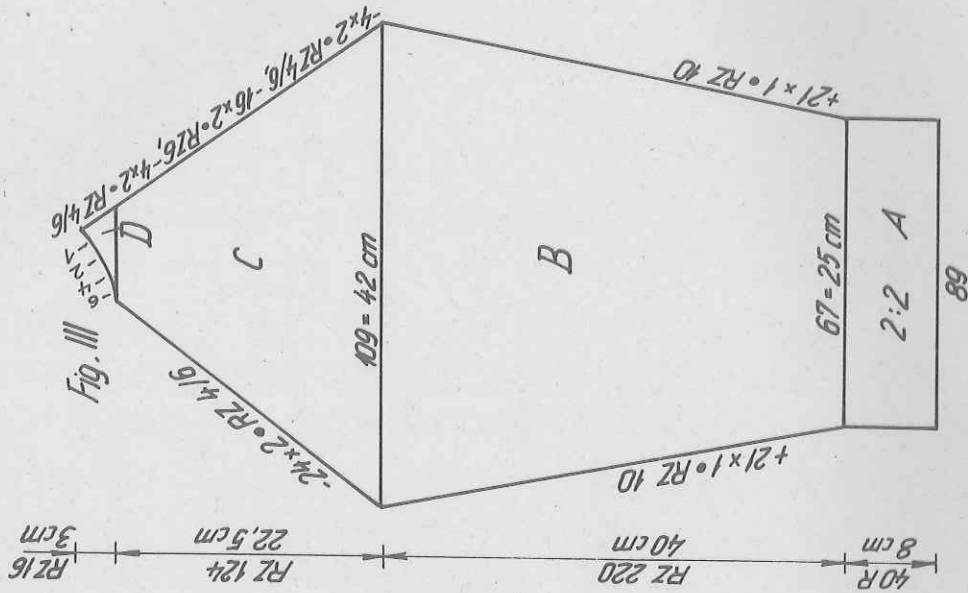
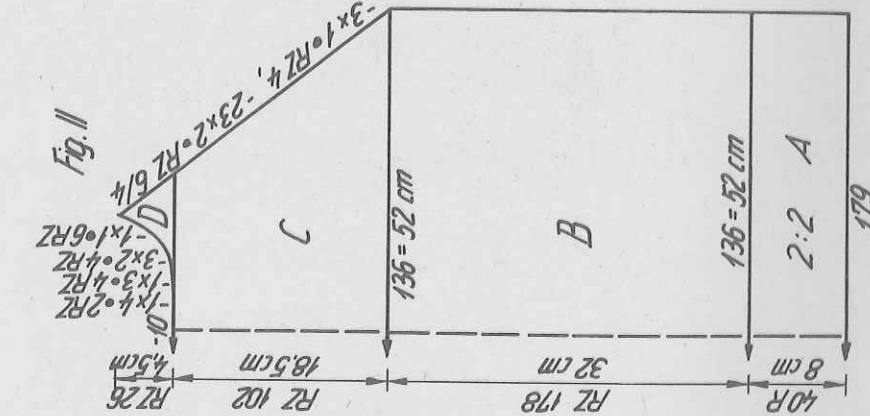
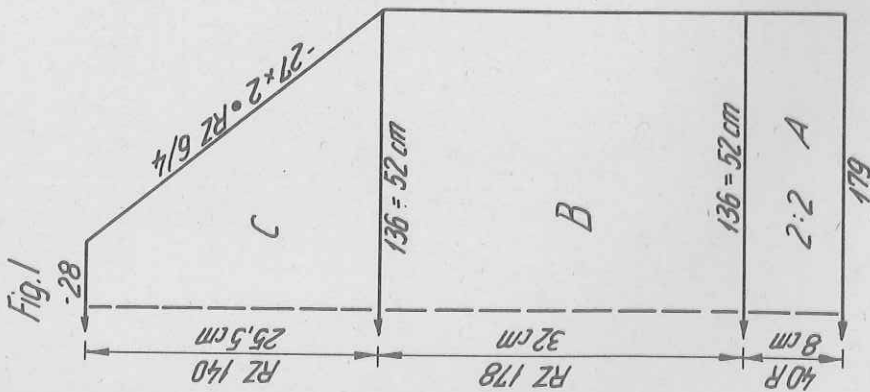

Fig. III : Sleeves

A = tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 89 sts over a width of 67 nds. B =
 transfer sts for half fisherman's rib, cont. to knit RC 28 med.red,
 RC 28 light red, repeat, inc. each end. C = shape raglan each end. D =
 shape neck at left. Knit second sleeve with reversed shapings.

Fig. IV : Collar

Tubular cast on for K/K with 100 sts, knit in half fisherman's rib,
 beginning with RC 12 dark red, then RC 12 med.red, RC 12 light red,
 repeat once. Knit 2 rows with lock back and front N. Cast off loosely.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under damp cloth. Sew pocket in position, keeping pattern correct, and folding 1 st each side to inside; attach lower end st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Join shoulder seam. Join the two collar parts with mattress stitch, with right sides facing, sew to neck edge. Sew in zip, taking it only up to half of the collar, use backstitch and make sure the zip 'teeth' are still visible when sewn in. Fold collar in half to inside and sew in position. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.

Fig. V : Buttonhole band and button band.

For buttonhole band make single-bed cast on with 160 sts, stocking st, knit 5 rows. Then, for buttonholes, knit 5 sts, *knit off 3 sts with contrast yarn by hand, knit 12 sts*. Repeat 3 times from * to *, knit 10 rows st.st, then repeat buttonholes, knit 5 rows st.st. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release. Knit button band in the same way but omit buttonholes, and with 68 sts only.

Raglan trimming : Knit once

Single-bed cast on with 100 sts, knit 20 rows. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Block and press parts lightly. Join raglan seam at left on back and front part. Sew the trimming band to this raglan seam, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, fold in half, hem in position (trimming band should hide the seam). Attach collar to neck edge. Bind the raglan edge at right with the buttonhole band, closing the short top edge, attach st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravel contrast yarn, sew to inside. Neaten buttonholes. Attach button band in the same way, join remaining open seam from inside. Join side seams. Attach buttons.

Material : 1040 g acrylic/wool. 1 zip fastener, open-ended, 78 cms.

Stitch size : Pattern = 7. Bands and collar = 5/2.

Collar : 100 sts = 32 cm, 100 R = 26 cm

Pattern : Acc. to diagram. Bands in 2:2 rib.

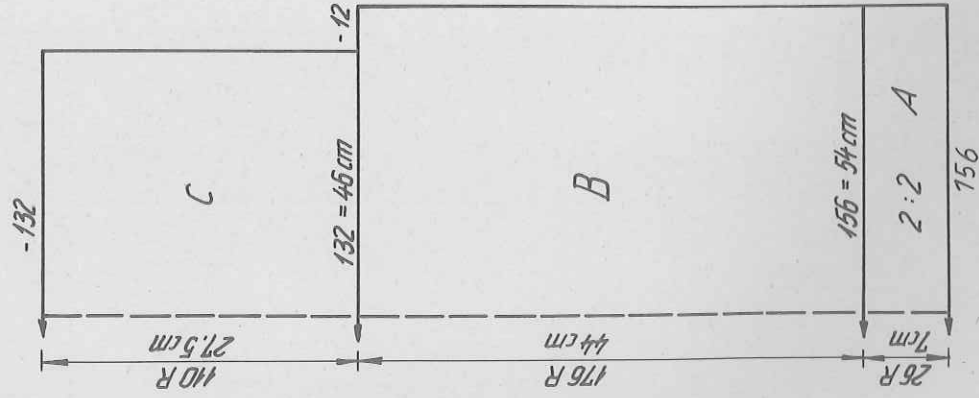

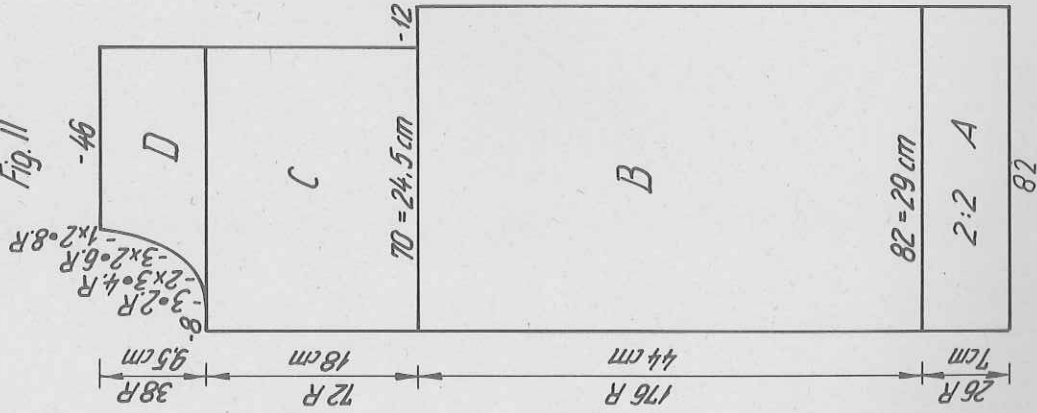

A = tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 84 sts over a width of 56 nds. B = transfer sts acc. to diagram, cont. to knit, inc. at each end. C = cont. straight. Cast off loosely.

Fig. IV : Collar, knit 2 parts with reversed shapings.

A = tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 24 sts over a width of 18 nds. Inc. at left. B = cont. straight. C = dec. at left. Cast off remaining sts loosely.

Fig. VI : Pocket, knit 2 alike

A = tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 38 sts over a width of 29 sts. B = transfer sts acc. to diagram, knit 60 rows. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

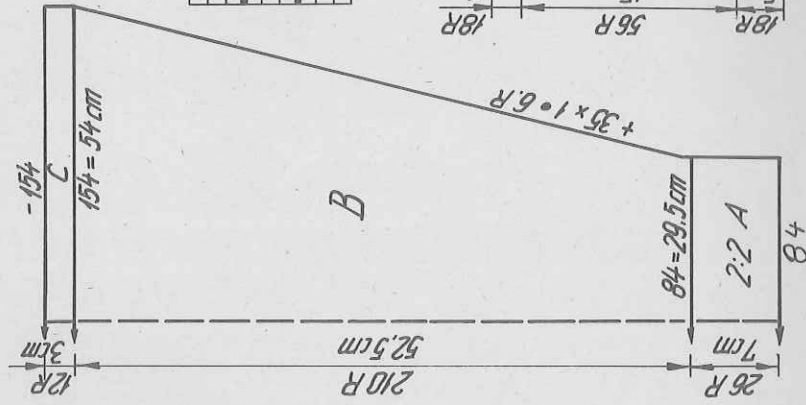
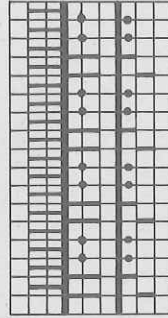
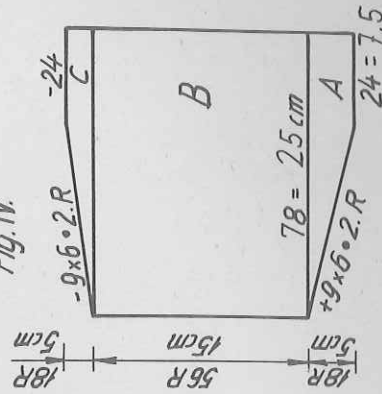


Diagram for pattern

Size : 88-92 cm bust
Material : 1060 g Polyacrylic/Wool. 1 Fastener.
Pattern : 6. Binding = 7. Stocking st = 7.
Stitch size : 100 sts = 40 cm, RC 100 = 23 cm
Test square : Acc. to diagram. Binding in stocking stitch.

Fig. I : Back
A = closed cast on, tubular, every alt. nd in WP. B = cont. to knit acc. to diagram, dec. at each end. C = cont. straight. D = cast off at each end. Cont. to knit, dec. at each end. E = cont. straight. F = shape shoulders at each end. Cast off remaining sts loosely.

Fig. II : Front
A = closed cast on, tubular, every alt. nd in WP. B = cont. to knit acc. to diagram, dec. at each end. C = knit straight. D = cast off at right, cont. to knit, dec. at right. E = cont. straight. F = shape neck at left. G = shape shoulder at right. Knit 2nd front part with reversed shapings.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two alike
A = single-bed cast on with contrast yarn, cont. in st. st. B = transfer sts acc. to diagram, cont. to knit in pattern. C = inc. at each end. D = knit straight. E = shape sleeve head at each end. Cast off rem. sts loosely.

Fig. IV : Collar (wrong side out)
A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, cont. to knit acc. to diagram. B = dec. at each end. Cast off remaining sts loosely.
Binding for edges : Knit two. Begin and end with contrast yarn.
Single-bed cast on over the whole width of needle bed. Knit 16 rows.
Binding for collar :

Single-bed cast on with 160 sts, knit 16 rows, end with contrast yarn, release. To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under damp cloth. Bind front edge from beginning of collar down to hem, attach binding st by st with backstitch (down to waist on both sides), from waist to hem (backstitch on the outside, slip stitch on inside). Collar : Sew on binding, st by st with backstitch on the outside, slip stitch on under-side. Attach collar to neck opening, making the seam on the outside as far as the shoulder, then on the inside along the back part. Sew seam band into shoulder seam as well as front neck edge, so the seams don't stretch. Set in sleeves. Fold 15 cms at front sleeve to inside, slip stitch into position, st by st, unravel contrast yarn. Then fold to outside. Attach fastener to front where desired.

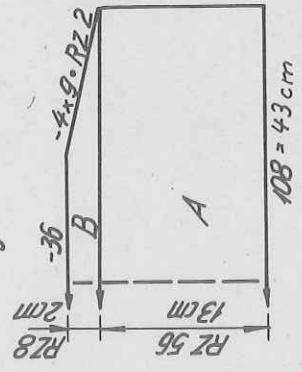
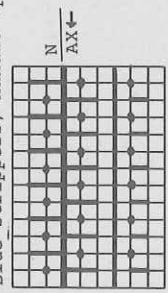


Diagram for pattern

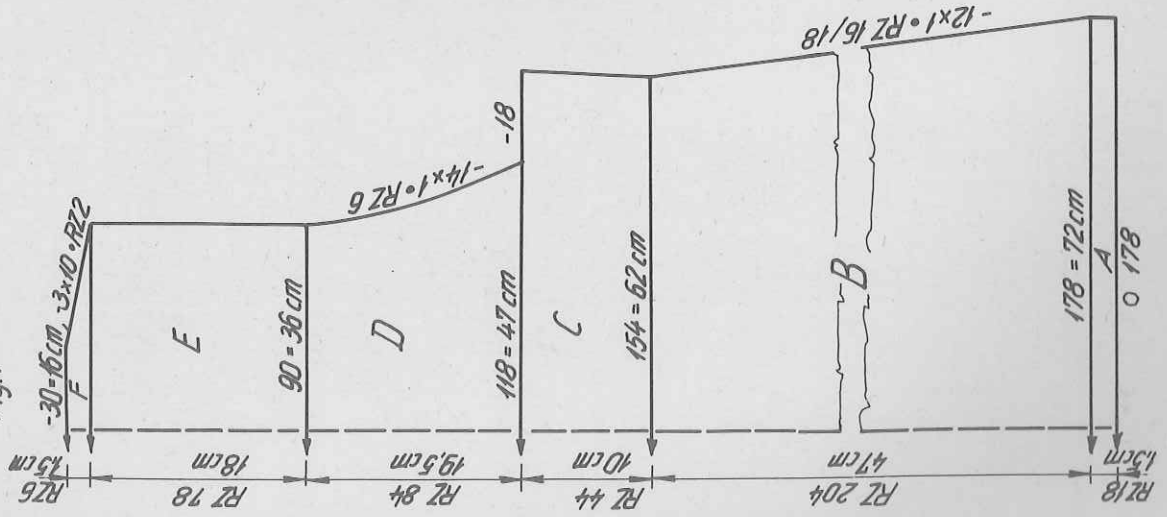

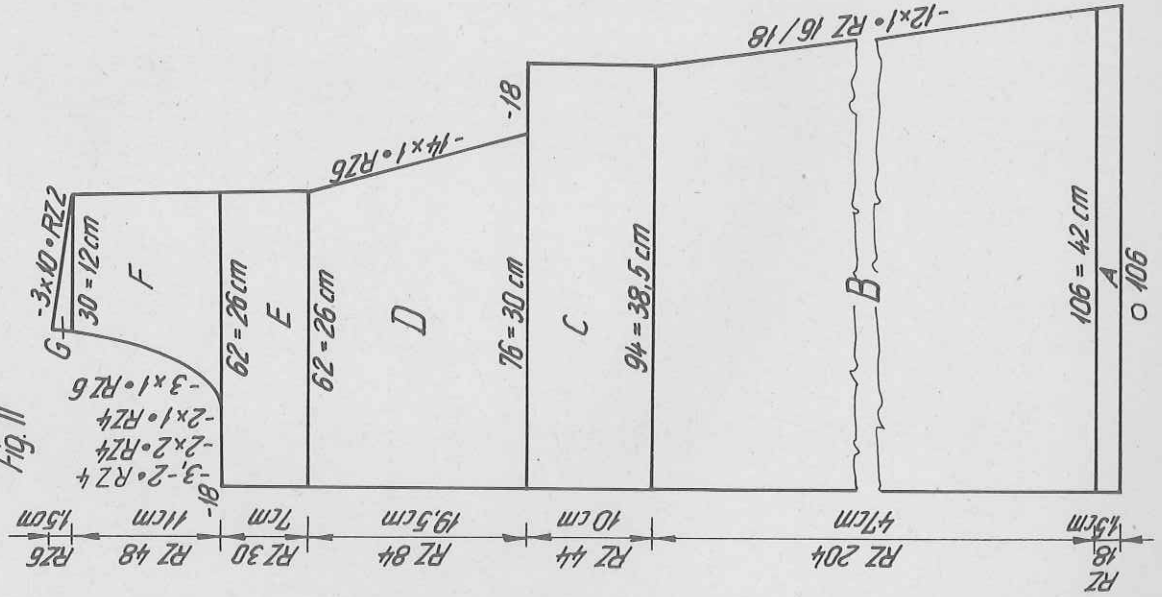
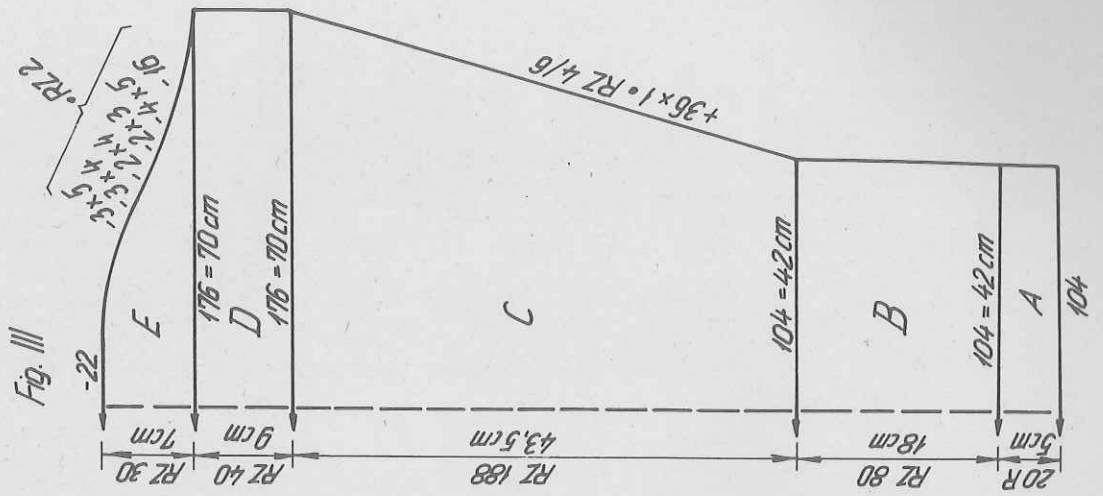

 Material : 390 g medium yarn, waist elastic 70 cm long
 Stitch size : Stocking stitch = 6/2. Waistband = 5/2
 Test square : 100 sts = 34 cm, 100 R = 26 cm
 Pattern : Stocking stitch (purl), pleats stocking stitch (jersey)

390 m length per 100 g
 122 yds per 1 oz
 10 cm = approx. 4"

Fig. VIII : Back skirt panel
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, knit 2 rows. Transfer sts for st.st., cont. to knit, at the same time dec. at each end. B = reduce sts by a quarter, i.e. always transfer the 4th st onto the 3rd st. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.
 Fig. VIIa : Front skirt panel
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, knit 2 rows. Transfer sts acc. to diagram starting from the right, lock front and back N, cont. to knit, dec. at left. B = reduce sts by a quarter, i.e. transfer ev. 4th st on to the 3rd st, all sts on the front bed, knit straight. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

Fig. VIIb : Front skirt panel
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, knit 2 rows. Transfer sts : transfer the first 14 sts at left onto back bed, all other sts onto front bed, lock at front and back N, cont. to knit, dec. at right. B = reduce sts by a quarter, i.e. transfer ev. 4th st onto the 3rd sts, knit straight. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.
 To make up : Block and press parts. Join front panels with purlside out. Join side seams. Arrange pleats on waistband and sew in position with mattress stitch. Fold waistband in half to inside and graft to main part, unravelling contrast yarn and leaving an opening of 2cms to insert waist elastic.

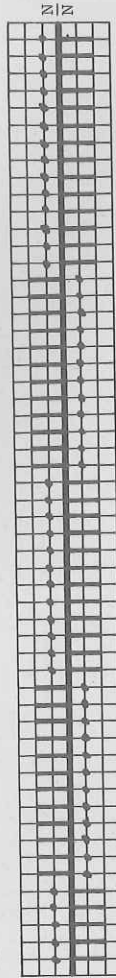

Hood : 100 sts = 50 cm, 100 R (RC 200) = 35 cm
- Pattern : Acc. to diagram 2. Bands acc. to diagram 1.
Hood stocking stitch, tubular.

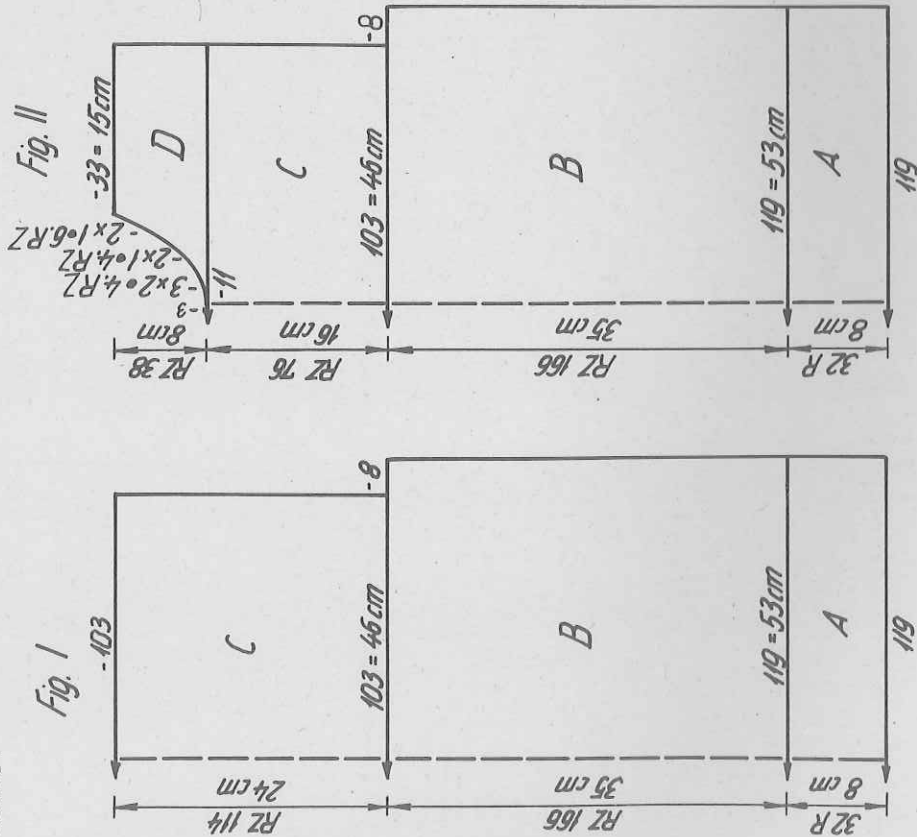

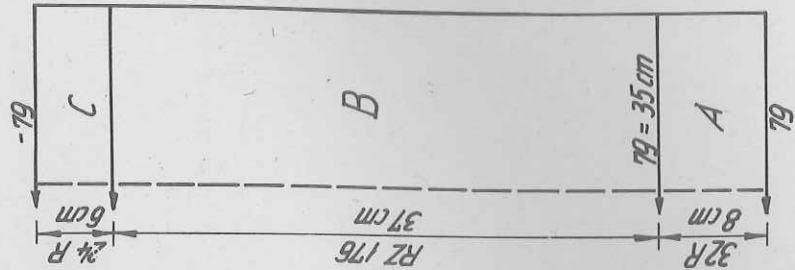

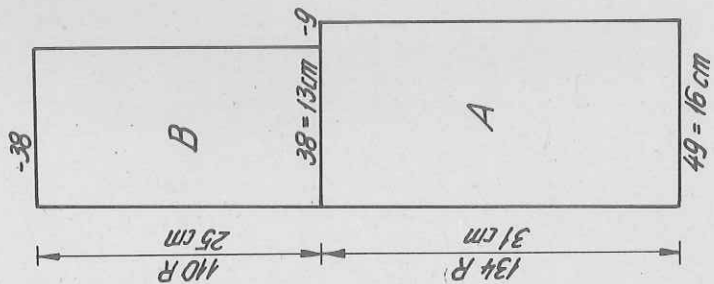

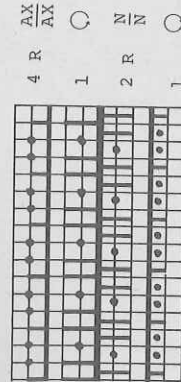

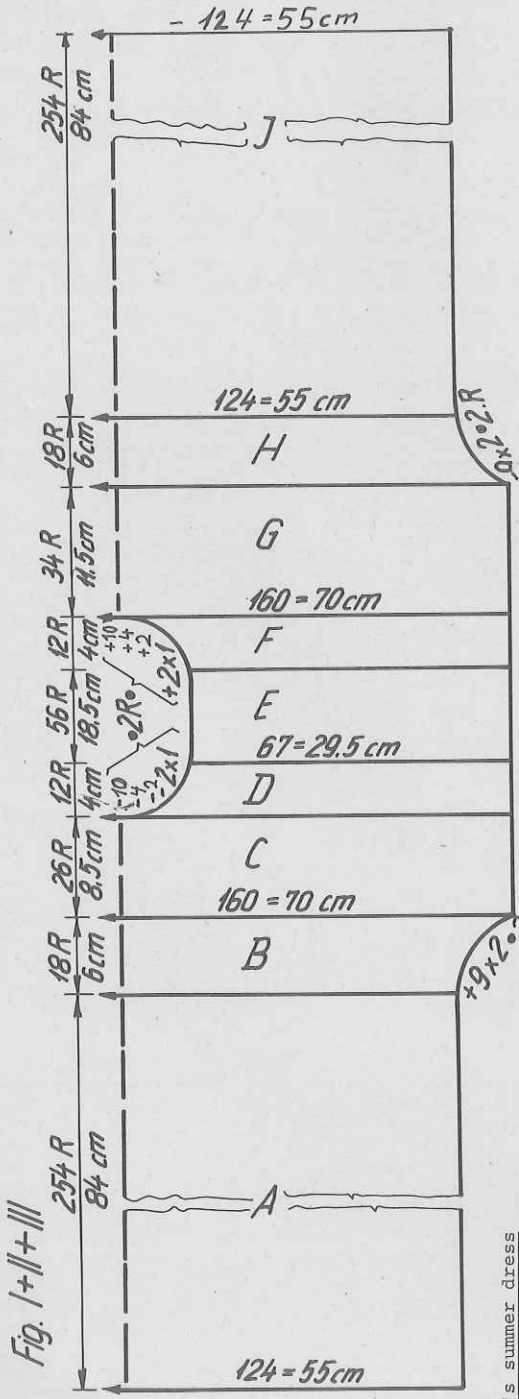

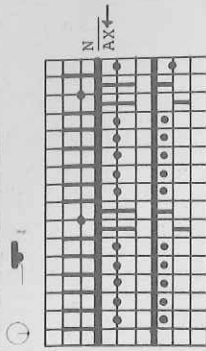

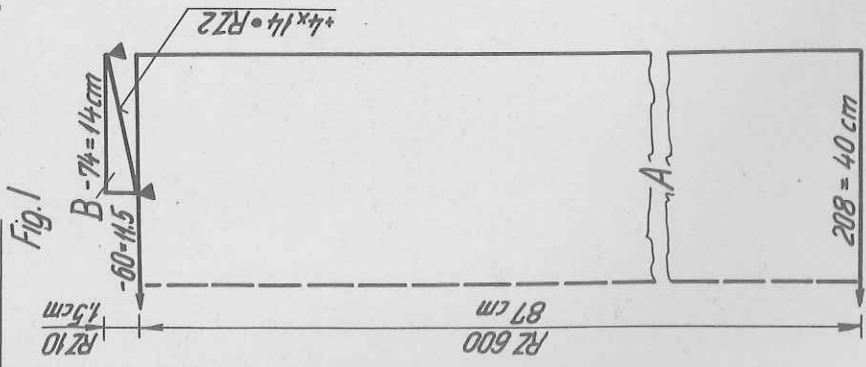

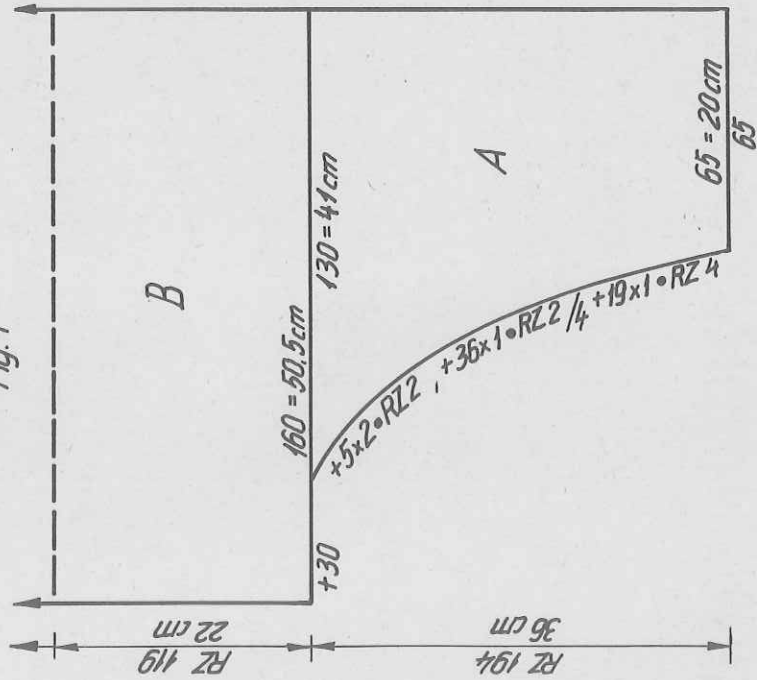

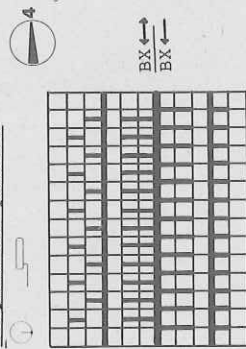

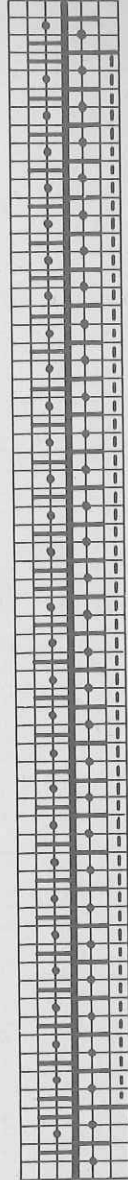

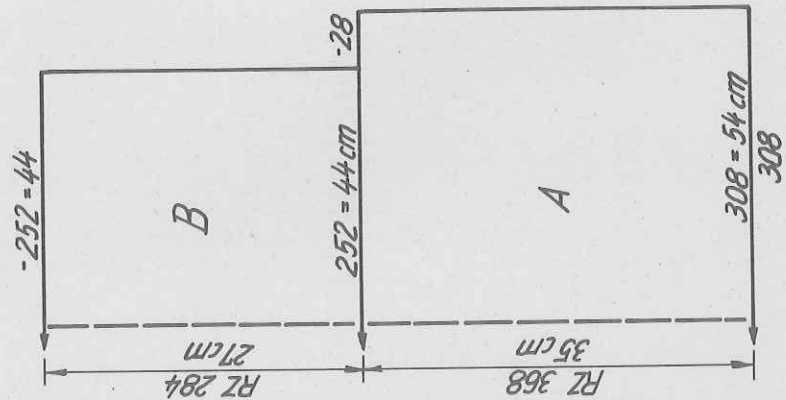

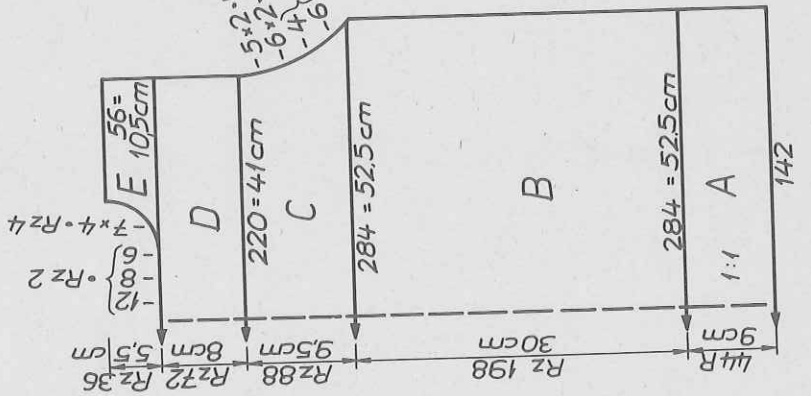

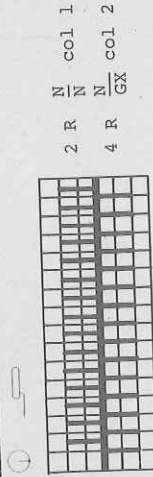
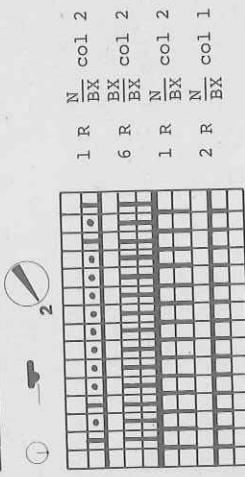


Diagram for pattern 2

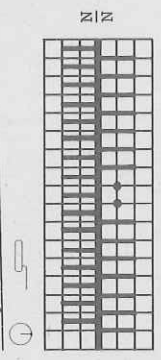
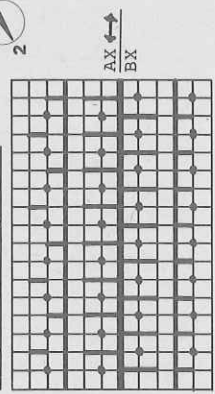


Diagram 1 for pattern

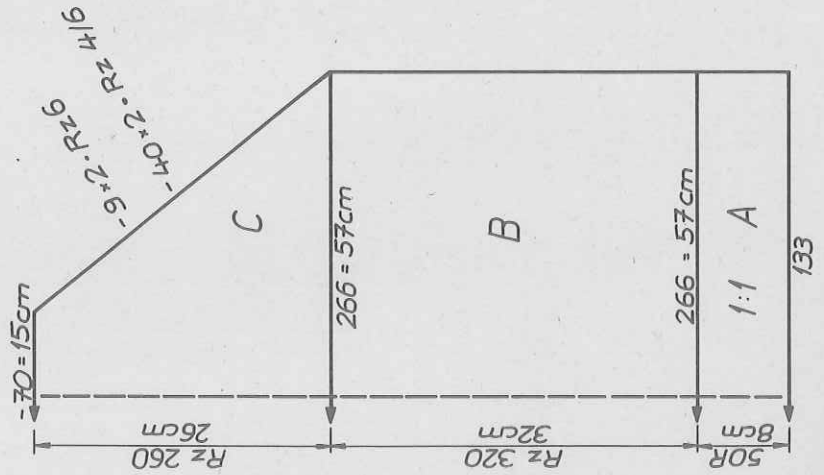

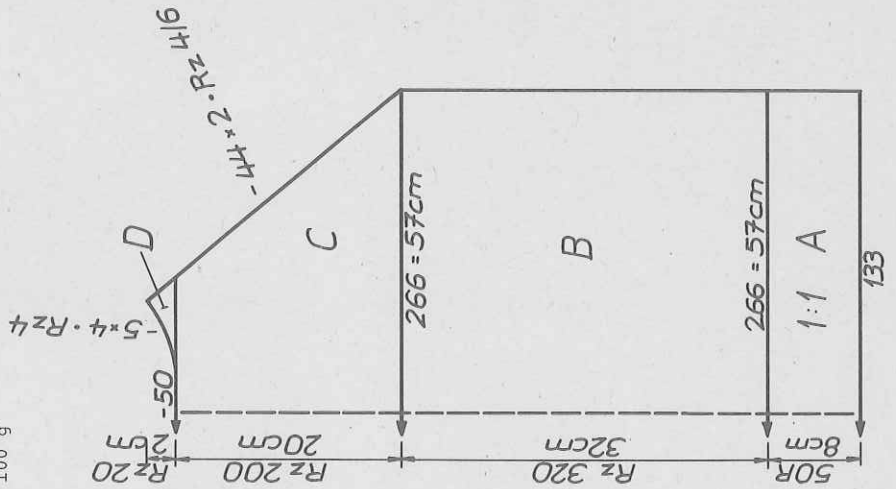

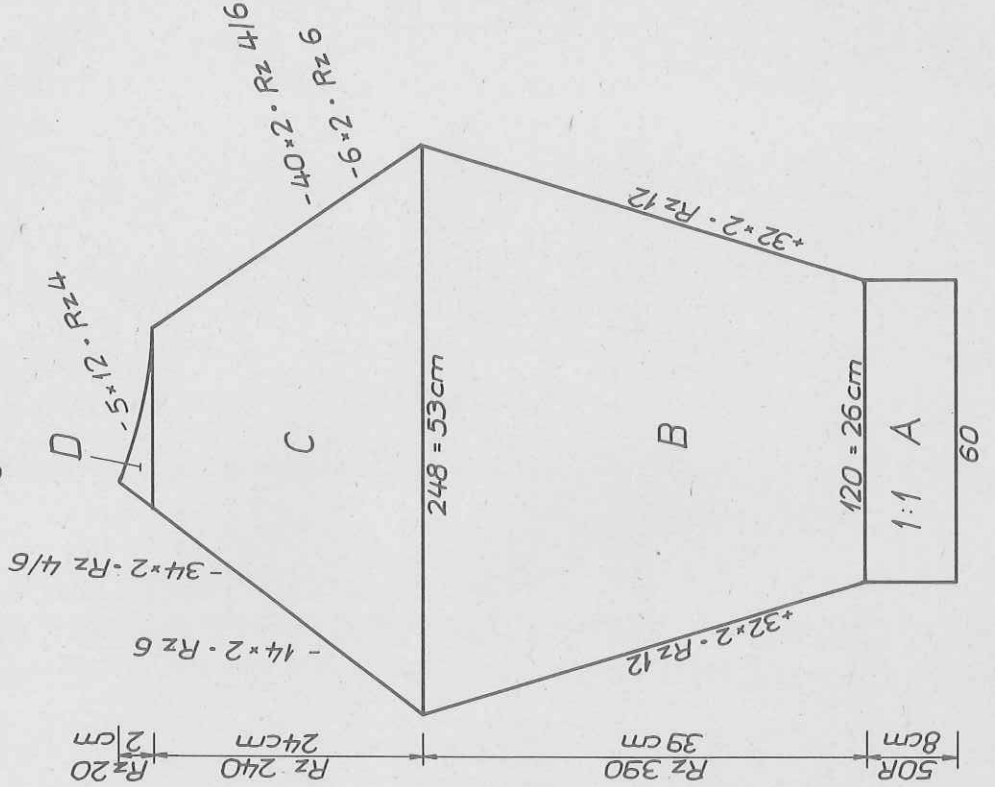

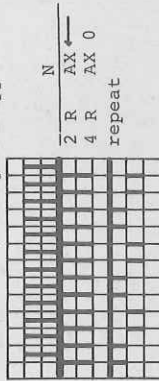


Diagram 2
Handle down, orange strippers

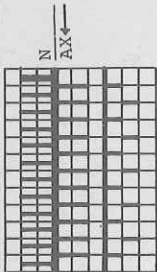


Diagram 3 : Half Fisherman's rib

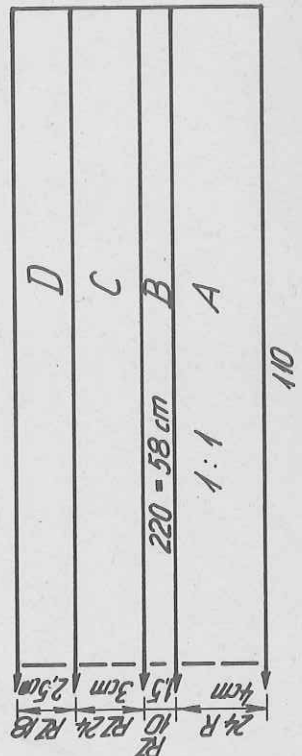
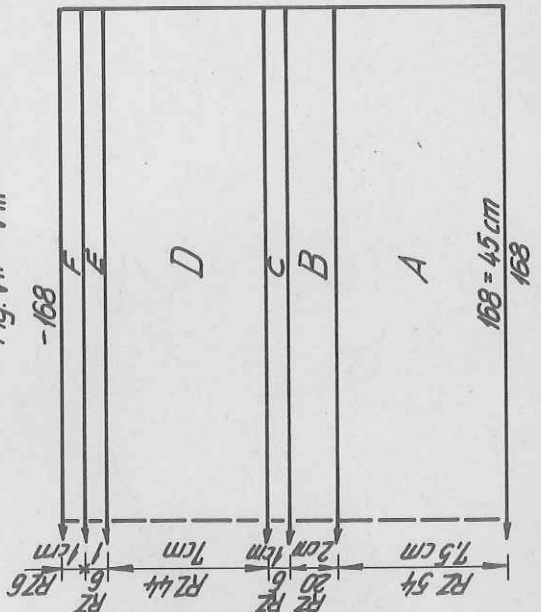
